Club X members vying for weanling bragging rights

Breeders clash in jovial bid to land knockout blow at Magic Millions foal sale

Eleven months in the making, the order of selling has been determined and the banter is about to reach fever pitch as members of Club X - made up of Australian racing and breeding luminaries - go head-to-head on the Gold Coast next month.

There will be eight foals (and potentially nine, but more on that later) by stallions such as Territories (Invincible Spirit), Defcon (Choisir), Soobog (Snitzel) and Artie Schiller (El Prado)

who hold particular interest at next month's 725-lot catalogue at the Magic Millions Gold Coast National Weanling Sale

Not because of their blueblood pedigrees or their elite "physicals" but because the Club X members' foals are vying for far more than just a sales ring windfall on their owners' behalf.

It is unlikely they will be setting auction records, but for the Club X gang, the bidding and at what number the hammer falls will hold plenty of significance.



Riddle Me That (2 g ex Justine Coup by Entrepreneur), an impressive first-start winner at Benalla yesterday over 1106 metres, has provided promising first season sire Deep Field (Northern Meteor) with his eighth juvenile success this season. Bred and owned by Aqua Trained Thoroughbreds, the Matt Laurie-trained Riddle Me That was sent to the lead and proved too fast, winning by two and a half lengths over the Anthony Freedman-trained It'sayesfromme (Dundee). The Lindsay Park-trained stablemate Floreat Pica (Hinchinbrook) and Majestic Missile (Smart Missile) were third and fourth respectively. Riddle Me That joins Karrakatta Plate (Gr 2, 1200m) winner Dig Deep and Pago Pago Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) winner Cosmic Force among the first crop winners for the Newgate Farm-based Deep Field.

<<Continued from page 1 the highest-priced Club X foal will earn bragging rights over their fellow Group 1-winning trainers, leading studmasters and successful breeders who are more attune to selling seven-figure yearlings than buying and selling from mares purchased for, at most, \$10,000 at last year's Magic Millions National Sale.

The resulting foals will be offered at the Gold Coast next month.

Cornerstone Stud's Sam Hayes will consign two Club X lots, two fillies by Darley shuttler Territories (Lots 2 and 307), while Sledmere Stud's Treen and Royston Murphy are also in charge of two weanlings, colts by Real Saga (Tale Of The Cat) (Lot 209) and Dream Ahead (Diktat) (Lot 417).

Hayes owns Lot 2, while Lot 307 is owned by fellow South Australian breeder Chris Watson of Mill Park Stud who is fresh off claiming leading vendor owners (by average) at the Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale.

"I am only in my first year but it is a handy way of passing time at a long broodmare sale and it is fun competition between mates. We buy a mare and it has to be under \$10,000," Hayes told ANZ Bloodstock News.

"The moment it walks onto the ramp, the first person to put their emoji up on the Whatsapp group can bid on it, so you can't bid against each other.

"Once you have nominated you have to go \$10,000. It is quite fun because, as vendors as well, some of the guys are selling horses so they run you straight up to \$10,000 because they know you aren't allowed to stop.

"The rule is you get the foal out and you have to sell it the next year as a weanling and there are a series of prizes for whomever sells for the most.

"There are a lot of prominent breeders in it and the banter we have throughout the year is hilarious."

There are at least 11 entrants vying for supremacy in this year's Club X, the second running of the competition, but three have fallen at the first hurdle and failed to reach the "final" - two foals and a mare died and another foal inexplicably was not entered for the sale - leaving eight still in the game.

That weanling could be a late entry in the supplementary catalogue despite the breeder (who we won't name) contravening the rules by not meeting the initial deadline. The faux pas created much mirth and, of course, more banter.

"It probably costs you money but Barry Bowditch and the guys at

Magic Millions love it because we prop up (the market)," Hayes said.

"We bought 12 mares between us but we bid on about 95 so it really underpins the bottom end of the market."

As for Hayes' and Watson's Territories weanlings, there could be some "Fine Cotton" skullduggery going on when potential buyers come to inspect the two fillies.

"Chris Watson and I are in it and I am selling Chris' horse, so that is not going to get out of the box very often and that is what I have told him," Hayes said.

"I am getting a lot of heat for being lot 2 because I didn't plan that very well. I bought a mare called Back Story and the Territories out of Back Story is Lot 2.

"Chris' coincidentally happened to be Territories filly as well. His reports will be well and truly doctored up every day. I think I'll underplay it quite a bit.

"There is a lot of talk going on about it right now on our Whatsapp group."

Treen Murphy, the mastermind of the scheme, said the first year had provided some strong pinhook results with husband Royston winning the 2018 competition.

"The first year I bid on a mare in foal to Spirit Of Boom. I was \$10,000 and Sefton Park jumped in at \$11,000, so I wasn't allowed to bid any more," Murphy said.

"That foal came back through as a weanling and made \$150,000. That could have been in group. Roy's foal made \$40,000, making him the winner last year, and as a resulting pinooker made \$150,000 at the Magic Millions (in January)."

Newhaven Park's John Kelly will present a filly from the first crop of Eureka Stud-based sire Defcon (Lot 442) while Vinery Stud has a colt by Kitchwin Hills' young sire Sooboog (Lot 347) and Riversdale has a filly by Artie Schiller (Lot 471).

Kitchwin Hills' Mick Malone also has a colt by Husson (Hussonet) (Lot 230), having paid \$10,000 for his mother Intierra (Zabeel) carrying the foal at last year's sale.

Win, lose or draw, a post-sale Club X dinner has been organised, but Murphy warned that it was likely the last-placed member was set to foot the bill. And at the end of three weeks on the Coast, they are likely to be thirsty.

Eustace confident in Gaby

Co-trainer David Eustace believes Loving Gaby (I Am Invincible) is a worthy favourite for tomorrow's Champagne Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) at Randwick. The filly will be looking to post her first Group 1 victory, having been last seen finishing a brave second in Sires' Produce Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m). "She's favourite and on form should be, so hopefully she gets the job done," Eustace said. "It would be a great way to end the carnival. We're now on a drier track which is probably going to suit every horse but we're confident she's going to be better on top of the ground too."

Blinkers on Le Romain

Multiple Group 1 winner Le Romain (Hard Spun) will have the blinkers applied when he attempts to go one better than in the last two runnings of the All-Aged Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Randwick tomorrow. Kris Lees feels Le Romain is going just as well as he has in past seasons and hopes the addition of blinkers can give the horse a winning attitude to match. "He's worn winkers a few times and I thought a bit of a change, with a view to dropping him back in distance, might just be something to stimulate him a bit," Lees said. "He had a few days at the beach and went on the water walker for a couple of days, then he had a gallop Tuesday morning in the blinkers and pleased me. He rarely runs a bad race so I expect him to be thereabouts again."

Dark Eyes ready to step up at Caulfield

Dark Eyes (Snitzel) will look to snap losing streak that stretches back to his win in the 2017 Goulburn Cup (1600m) when he lines up in the Victoria Handicap (Gr 3, 1400m) at Caulfield tomorrow. Formerly trained by Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott, Dark Eyes runs for the fourth time for Dale and has undergone a change from



his Moruya stable to Canberra since finishing last at Randwick on March 2. "He wasn't going well in his first few runs for us, so we changed his routine and his stable," Dale said. "He's an older gelding that hasn't been wanting to apply himself but we've seen signs at home that he's more forward and focused. I'm not thinking he can win by any means down there as his best form is over more distance, but what I want to see from him is a more competitive performance and that will give us somewhere to go and roll with."

Queensland campaign on cards for Red Alto

Brent Stanley has earmarked races during the Queensland winter carnival as targets for Bendigo Cup (Gr 3, 2400m) winner Red Alto (High Chaparral) but first the stayer will try to win the Easter Cup (Gr 3, 2000m) at Caulfield tomorrow. "If he gets the right run in the race he could easily win. He's just not 100 per cent at his peak yet," Stanley said. "There's probably a few races in Queensland for him that I've earmarked. Queensland is his main goal. He likes soft tracks as well so we'll head up there with him." The Doomben Cup (Gr 1, 2000m) and Brisbane Cup (Gr 2, 2400m) are among the options, with Stanley to make a decision after Saturday whether the gelding heads straight to Brisbane for his next start.

Addictive Nature set for Caulfield return

Trainer Danny O'Brien will be hoping his decision to send Addictive Nature (Savabeel) to tomorrow's Odds Boost Handicap (1200m) at Caulfield rather than the Hall Mark Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) at Randwick. O'Brien said they had been looking for some soft ground but with both Randwick and Caulfield rated in the good range, it was decided to keep Addictive Nature in Melbourne for what looked an easier race. "He's had a nice build-up," O'Brien said. "We've had him for nearly three months now and he has

trialled well. He's a talented horse and I think he should run well. He's a lightly raced horse and if he can find his best form there would certainly be better races for him, either in Adelaide or Brisbane."

Thrillster in good order

Co-trainers Leon and Troy Corstens will be hoping Thrillster's (Starspangledbanner) long awaited return to the track in the Geoff Murphy Handicap (1100m) at Caulfield tomorrow will be a winning one. "(She's) really well, she's had the two trials leading into this, her trial last Friday was excellent," Corstens told Racing.com. "She's pretty sharp so I don't think the 1100m (of Saturday's race) is going to be an issue at all. I've got a guy looking at the speed and doing some maps for me today so we will make a decision tomorrow (Friday) on whether we are going to go forward or back. Probably need to watch how the track is playing on Saturday as well, so I won't make a decision on that until tomorrow, which I know doesn't help the punters out there, but we have to look after the horse as well."

All Over Bosanova to step out for Stokes

Phillip Stokes admits it has taken All Over Bosanova (Court Command) some time to familiarise herself with running anti-clockwise as the mare prepares for her first Melbourne start for her new trainer. But Stokes believes the sprinter is getting the hang of it and expects to learn more about the speedy mare when she makes her debut for his stable in tomorrow's Noel Rundle Handicap (1100m) at Caulfield in which she is among the leading contenders. "She came down from Sydney with reasonable form and she's very quick," Stokes said. "We had a little bit of trouble getting her used to changing her lead legs and going this way of going, but she is starting to really get the hang of it now. It's a little bit of a watch and see on Saturday because we're still learning our way

with her, but I'm happy with her work. Caulfield is probably not the ideal track to be starting a horse off this way of going but if she gets around the track she will give them something to chase for a while."

I'm A Rippa on track for Stradbroke

The lure of a likely dry winter has trainer Tony Gollan setting I'm A Rippa (Love Conquers All) on a path to the Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1400m). I'm A Rippa makes his return to racing in the Ascot Handicap (Listed, 1200m) at Doomben tomorrow. Last winter, I'm A Rippa won the BRC Sprint (Gr 3, 1200) to go with his win earlier in the year in the Magic Millions QTIS race (1200m). "We skipped the Magic Millions and Sydney autumn because of the fact Eagle Farm is back in play," Gollan said. "The prediction is for a dry winter and Eagle Farm is such a good drying track. That is the key to I'm A Rippa - a dry track. I know he has won on a soft track but he has had 19 good track starts and won seven of them with eight minor placings."

Ceol Na Mara on trial for Oaks

The Chris Munce-trained Ceol Na Mara (Your Song) will be on trial for a tilt at the Queensland Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) when she lines up in the Princess Stakes (Listed, 1600m) at Caulfield tomorrow. "The series was a good idea because it helped trainers get an idea if they had a staying three-year-old and also helped to boost prize-money," Munce said. "From here Ceol Na Mara can take the usual path to the Oaks through the Gold Coast Bracelet, The Roses and then the Oaks." Ceol Na Mara is raced by one of Queensland's leading owners Bill Andrews and his brother John. "Bill and John have had plenty of success in the winter but they would love to win a Group 1 race," he continued.

Cassidy links with Godolphin

Larry Cassidy gets the chance to continue his good strike rate with the powerful Godolphin stable after securing the key ride on Plague Stone (Lonhro) at Doomben. Plague Stone will be Godolphin's first runner of the winter carnival when he contests Saturday's Mick Dittman Plate (Listed, 1100m). Plague Stone

has had two trials to prepare for the winter, winning the latest at Rosehill two weeks ago. "It is always an honour to ride for Godolphin. You know whenever you get on a Godolphin horse you have a real chance," Cassidy said.

Currie gains another QCAT stay

Toowoomba trainer Ben Currie has been granted an extension of a stay which will allow him to continue training through Easter. Currie gave phone evidence yesterday from Bali where he is at a wedding, during a hearing in the Queensland Civil and Administrative Tribunal (QCAT). He was suspended in February when stewards charged him with seven offences which were the result of text messages discovered on his phone. Currie sought an internal review and was granted a stay pending the result of that review. The internal reviewer found against Currie and he went back to QCAT to get a further extension of the stay. Currie faces 42 allegations in total and has also been training on a separate stay but Thursday's hearing only involved the seven charges from February. Some other charges are set down to be heard or finalised next week. Currie has not been found guilty on any of the 42 allegations to date.

Debate over meaning of harped up'

Much of yesterday's hearing regarding Ben Currie was taken up with argument about the meaning of the words "harped" and "harped up" found on the trainer's phone. Stewards have alleged the comments involve the use of a jigger or electrical device on horses. Currie told the hearing he had used the words to mean a horse was being primed or fine-tuned with a strong gallop and he had no knowledge of jiggers or electrical devices. He told the hearing he could not understand why anyone would use a jigger or electrical device. "They would be useless. A horse can only go so fast. You can't make them go faster," Currie said. "I have been saying they (harped and harped up) can have multiple meanings." Scott McLeod QC, for the Queensland Racing Integrity Commission, made reference to ten statements made by various jockeys and trainers regarding their understanding of the words harped and harped up. Jim Murdoch QC, for Currie, said it was

important to note Currie had not been found guilty on any charge.

Zahra loses appeal

Mark Zahra has failed in his appeal against the severity of a lengthy careless riding suspension incurred at Randwick last Saturday. Zahra was banned for 25 meetings and fined \$3800 for careless riding aboard the winner of the Fernhill Handicap (Listed, 1600m) in Power Scheme (Fiorente), resulting in two horses and their jockeys Andrew Adkins and Glyn Schofield falling in the concluding stages of the race. Zahra's appeal was dismissed yesterday with his ban to begin on April 23 and end on June 1. Zahra is booked for four rides at Randwick tomorrow including Power Scheme in the Champagne Stakes and another four at Sandown on Monday before his ban begins.

Jockey McNeil wins reprieve

Fellow Melbourne-based jockey Jye McNeil had more success at yesterday's appeal, with the Tribunal overturning both the conviction and penalty of a ten-meeting careless riding suspension for his ride on Fifty Stars (Sea The Stars) in the Doncaster Mile (Gr 1, 1600m). McNeil will be in action at Caulfield tomorrow with his rides including Furrlion (Camelot) in the Easter Cup (Gr 3, 2000m).

Lee Smith suspended

Victorian country jockey Lee Smith has been suspended for four months after testing positive to a banned substance last month. Smith provided the positive sample at Benalla on March 19 and was stood down on April 9, with the jockey pleading guilty to the offence. He is allowed to return to riding trackwork once he provides a clear sample. Smith, 42, is banned from race riding until August 9.

Meech's collarbone injury confirmed

Victorian jockey Linda Meech is expected to be out of the saddle for about a month after suffering a fractured collarbone in a race fall at Geelong. Meech was dislodged from La Lova (Street Boss) just after the start of the final race on Wednesday's program when the mare knuckled when she came out of the barrier. Scans confirmed the collarbone fracture but

it the injury will not require surgery. Meech is leading the Victoria statewide premiership by 28 wins this season on 114 winners while she sits third on the national standings.

New Zealand

Tiley underplays Easter Handicap hand

Nigel Tiley has no expectation that he can repeat his Easter Handicap (Gr 2, 1600m) win of last year despite having twice the hand in tomorrow's Ellerslie feature. Tiley won the race from his home base of Pukekohe last year with Megablast (Shinko King), taking advantage of heavy 10 conditions during a period when the Ellerslie track was undergoing renovation work. Four-year-old Demonetization (All Too Hard) joins Megablast in the Easter Handicap, set to be run on a dead 4 surface at worst with no rain forecast before the race. "He's not as forward as he was last year. He was ready to go last year," Tiley said. "If it was a bottomless track this weekend, he'd be some chance but there's no chance of that and I think they'll go too quick for him. He'll be on a plane for Brisbane on the third of May and this race will bring him on for that."

Orepuki Lad shoots for third feature

Orepuki Lad (Raise The Flag), who has won the Dunedin Gold Cup (Listed, 2400m) and the Invercargill Gold Cup (2600m) this preparation, will attempt to bring up the cups trifecta in tomorrow's Riverton Cup (Listed, 2147m). "It would be great to win our home cup. I don't think it has ever been done before, one horse winning the three cups in a year, it would be great to do it," co-trainer Graham Eade said. Orepuki Lad is coming off a last-start fifth-placing in the Hororata Gold Cup (1800m) and Eade believes his charge will appreciate the step up in distance tomorrow. "It was a very good run last start," he said. "It was only 1800m and there were some very good horses in there and he still ran fifth and wasn't far off the winner. The longer it gets, the better for him."

Melbourne spring on radar for Avantage

Te Akau Racing trainer Jamie Richards says

comeback mare Avantage (Fastnet Rock) will not race again this season and instead will be prepared for a return to Australia and the Melbourne spring carnival. Richards elected to spell Avantage after her third-placed performance in the Arrowfield 3YO Sprint (Gr 2, 1200m) at Randwick. "We gave serious consideration to backing her up in Sydney on Saturday," Richards said. "We also thought about taking her to Brisbane, but ultimately we have decided to bring her home and give her a good break and get her ready for Melbourne in the spring. We do think she can be competitive in those mares races in Melbourne and she looks pretty promising to us."

Te Akau's Queensland team under consideration

Jamie Richards is keen to identify the right horses to take to Queensland for the winter carnival in the coming weeks after ruling Avantage out of a trip to the sunshine state. "We'd like to try and find a two-year-old and we will keep working through those in the next couple of weeks, but there are a few there in the balance," Richards said. "Mongolianconqueror runs in the Easter Handicap off a light weight on Saturday and he could be set for the staying races over there. Our Abbadean is also in the mix. I was a little bit disappointed with her in the Breeders' Stakes (Gr.1, 1600m) but we will run her in the Travis Stakes and if she ran a lot better she could go too."

International

Zabeel Prince makes winning return

The Roger Varian-trained Zabeel Prince (6g Lope de Vega - Princess Serena by Unbridled's Song) made a winning return to the track, taking out the Earl Of Sefton Stakes (Gr 3, 1m1f) at Newmarket yesterday. The six-year-old gelding finished off strongly to beat, pulling two and three quarter lengths clear of Forest Ranger (Lawman), who finished second with Mustashry (Tamayuz) coming home in third. This was the second victory at stakes level for the gelding, having taken out the Doncaster Mile (Listed, 1m) last season.

Invincible Spirit colt goes for 575,000gns

A colt by Invincible Spirit (Green Desert) topped the second and final day of the Tattersalls Craven Breeze Up Sale on Wednesday, after being purchased by Anthony Stroud, accompanied as he had been on Tuesday by Sheikh Mohammed, for 575,000gns. Bred by the Niarchos family, the colt is out of Group 3 winner Mare Nostrum (Caerleon) making him a half-brother to Group 1 winner Erupt (Dubawi) and Listed-winning Marie De Medici (Medicean). "He's a very nice horse and did a very good breeze," said Stroud. "He showed a remarkable temperament having had to do it twice and he comes from a very good Niarchos family. Norman Williamson does a great job of preparing these horses." The colt was consigned by Oak Tree Farm and catalogued as **Lot 122**.

No Nay Never proves popular

A filly by Coolmore Stud's former shuttler No Nay Never (Scat Daddy) proved popular on the final day of the Tattersalls Craven Breeze Up Sale, after being snapped up by John and Jake Warren for 230,000gns. The sale of the filly was one of a number of strong results for Star Bloodstock, vendor of the likes of Abel Handy and Broken Stones, having been pinhooked from the Goffs UK Premier Sale for £40,000. "She's always been a quick, professional filly at home and I'm ecstatic with that result," said Star Bloodstock's Matt Eves. "We bought her from Doncaster just before the stallion really kicked on, we looked at everything there and she met all of our criteria - we're rigorous in our buying. If we'd try to buy the same filly in October she might've cost 100,000gns." The filly was catalogued as **Lot 79**.

American Pharoah filly makes 110,000gns

Another filly by another Coolmore Stud shuttler American Pharoah (Pioneerof The Nile) was snapped up for 110,000gns by Victoria de Sousa. The filly is out Listed-winning mare Iplaytricks (Desert Gold), who is herself a sister to Desert Tricks. The filly was **Lot 96** and consigned by Powerstown Stud. American Pharoah will stand for a fee of \$66,000 (inc GST).

Winx a joy to watch - live on course and on the TV

Winx brought an end to her illustrious career last Saturday at Randwick in front of a packed house and it was a sight to behold.

I watched the race at home. I made the decision to return to Melbourne after the Easter sales and watch her on TV and I wasn't disappointed in doing so.

I have been fortunate enough to see all her four Cox Plate wins, most of her Melbourne wins, and her two previous Queen Elizabeth successes.

For me Saturday wasn't the history-making win, her whole career was the part of history and I have been fortunate enough to see it up close and from afar.

You just keep shaking your head in disbelief, really, with the way Winx goes about it.

She runs sprinter sectionals at the end of a mile and a quarter and that is phenomenal to be able to do that. Chris Waller and his team have done a remarkable job with her.

It is an unbelievable effort from the team around her and the horse herself. She performed on wet or dry, 1200 metres to 2400 metres, and when you run those sectionals there is no such

thing as an easy run. I know she makes it look easy, but the clock suggests otherwise.

It has got to take a massive toll on her and for her to continually bounce back is demonstrated in the way she has been handled by connections in having three and four-run preparations.

They have done a miraculous job to keep her going for that length of time - stretching five years - and I think ultimately that is the key to her longevity.

You couldn't go to the well six or seven times in a preparation when she produces those performances.

I feel the greatest training masterstroke from Chris Waller was earlier in the career when she won the Doncaster in 2015, and after that he had the option to back her up into the Queen Elizabeth and he decided against that.

It just takes its toll and I learnt that from Black Caviar when she won an Orr Stakes and then I backed her up in the Lightning seven days later. I have said it before but that was the start of the end for her.

Those great horses never have an easy run even though they make it look easy visually because they apply themselves continually and run the time and sectionals that make them elite.

It is never a soft option for them.

There has also been plenty of debate and conjecture as to which stallion Winx will visit in the upcoming breeding season.

I will stay out of nominating an individual stallion, but what I will say is that the key to the great horses is to breed to the correct mating, not the fashion.

Who that is, I don't know, but there are people out there much better versed than me to make those decisions and hopefully one day we get to enjoy her progeny doing the job down the track.

Buying bench something to behold at Easter

The strength of last week's Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale was quite something to see unfold and it wasn't something I could have predicted myself when I inspected the horses.

When everyone had viewed the horses at Riverside stables there were sceptics, myself included, who questioned whether the quality horses was actually there.

But what can't be debated is that the buyers were there to buy the horses, which led to near record sales and a new benchmark for a single

day's trade.

Whether they were the big horses - and I was wrong - or the buying bench made them into big horses (price wise) is probably question only time will tell us the answer to.

After last week's events, Easter certainly holds its place as a showcase of international yearling sales. It really continues to surprise and maybe Inglis has learnt from the smaller catalogue to some degree.

I believe the decision to hold a two-day 450-lot catalogue was much about what was offered to the auction house to sell at that sale as much as the desire to have the smaller catalogue. But I have to say it worked, whatever led to the decision.

The buying bench Inglis provided at Easter meant that the vendors who provided the top lots were well rewarded and will continue to support the April sale.

The elite horses bred each year will continue to be shared by Inglis and Magic Millions, which also has a wonderful buying bench, but Easter, as I said, certainly confirmed its place in the top echelon of yearling sales anywhere in the world.

I sold one filly and bought a small share in a colt who was bought by a stud and a trainer. Realistically, I went there trying to buy a few but I never got hot. I was well off the pace unfortunately but you have to be realistic in your price on where you think they should be.

Sometimes you find a horse you like but too many other people are on them as well but you have got to be there because there is value to be found.

However, this year I couldn't find it but I am sure other people did.

It is just how it falls sometimes and if other people have a bigger budget than you, then you are just unlucky.

Overall, this year's major yearling sales are now done and dusted and what the results showed was that the industry is very vibrant and in a healthy state.

With the amount of prize-money on offer, it gives people the confidence to go out and invest in yearlings knowing that they are in with a great chance of getting the biggest return ever.

That sentiment is fueling the yearling prices and that will flow on now to the breeding stock sales which start next month.

The breeders will look to reinvest in that market which, ultimately, is mares being sold by people who raced them for a few years which in turn puts money back in their pocket and give them a chance to go again at the yearling sales next year.

It is a revolving door that helps everyone out.

Winx (Street Cry) wound up an amazing career with a fitting farewell victory in Saturday's Queen Elizabeth Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) at Randwick and the rising eight-year-old mare yet again demonstrating her brilliant turn of foot.

In the perfect finale, Winx took out the \$4 million race for the third year in a row in recording her 33rd successive win, her 25th Group 1 race and her 36th victory in 42 starts.

After settling back in fifth place, Hugh Bowman moved Winx up and wide out nearing the home turn, before dashing to the front and then going on to score comfortably from the Japanese-trained Kluger (King Kamehameha) with Hartnell (Authorized) in third.

Time for the 2000 metre journey was 2:02.54, with the leader Mask Of Time (Holy Roman Emperor) running solid sectionals for

the final 1600 metres that saw that section covered in a quick 1:34.44.

Winx in coming from the middle of the nine-horse field, returned impressive fast closing sectionals: 1:33.83 (last 1600m), 1:21.29 (last 1400m), 1:09.33 (last 1200m), 57.17 (last 1000m), 45.22 (last 800m), 33.82 (last 600m) and 22.49 for her final 400 metres.

The highlight, after coming off a quick tempo in a 2000 metre race, was her 200 metre breakdown over the final 600 metres: 11.33, 10.97 and 11.52 - which is 600 metres in 33.82.

A performance like that, at the end of her career, is a demonstration of Winx's remarkable ability and also testimony to the superb management skills and knowledge of her trainer Chris Waller.

The leading trainer, who appropriately recorded his 100th Group 1 success with

race with two contrasting sections – the leader clocking only 1:19.09 (13.18 200m rate) for the first 1200 metres before Hugh Bowman took Frankly Awesome (Frankel) to the front in the mid-stages, resulting in the leaders clocking 1:12.06 (12.01 200m rate) for the final 1200 metres.

And with Verry Elleegant back in tenth place with 1200 metres to run, she needed to produce a good turn of foot and she did, clocking 58.71 for the final 1000 metres, 46.18 (last 800m), 34.72 (last 600m) with her last 400 metre in 23.16.

A performance to suggest Verry Elleegant is likely to progress to the spring carnival with prospects in a race like the Caulfield Cup (Gr 1, 2400m).

The runner-up, the Mark Newnham-trained filly Scarlet Dream (Sebring) also returned fast closing times in coming from 11th to take second in a career-best performance.

Having only her seventh race start, Scarlet Dream clocked 58.90 (last 1000m), 46.59 (last 800m) 34.80 (last 600m) and 23.26 for her

final 400 metres. She is a filly to watch.

In the Sydney Cup, the Waller-trained/Irish-bred gelding Shraah (Sea The Stars) staged a solid staying effort under his limit-weight (51kg) to win by a long neck from fellow Irish-bred Vengeur Masque (Monsun) with the New Zealand mare Glory Days (Red Giant) third.

Time for the 3200 metre was 3:22.06 in another race split into two sections with the leaders clocking 2:09.55 (12.95 200m rate) for the first 2000 metres, while the final 1200 metres was clocked in 1:12.41 (12.06 200m rate).

The winner Shraah returned very smart closing times at the end of the testing journey with his last 1000 metres in 58.55, last 800 metres in 46.45, last 600 metres in 34.93 with his final 400 metres in 23.52.

While some of the quickest closing times in the race were recorded by the third-placed Glory Days, who was having her first Australian start after winning the Auckland Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) on March 9.

Glory Days clocked 58.23 for her last 1000

metres, 46.34 (last 800m), 35.01 (last 600m) with her final 400 metres in 23.47.

Earlier in the day, the progressive Les Bridge-trained Classique Legend (Not A Single Doubt) confirmed his potential, advancing quickly at his fourth start to record an impressive win in the Arrowfield 3YO Sprint (registered as Royal Sovereign Stakes) (Gr 2, 1200m).

Kerrin McEvoy elected to ride Classique Legend patiently on this occasion, settling back in seventh place before the gelding sprinted brilliantly off a fast pace to score decisively in the time of 1:09.18 on the soft 5 track.

Classique Legend's sectional times were exceptional with his last 1000 metres in 55.21, last 800 metres in 44.50, last 600 metres in 33.58 with his final 400 metres in 22.57.

The talented grey gelding is owned in Hong Kong but connections later advised that they would keep Classique Legend in Australia until at least the end of the year, Bridge now electing to spell the talented grey gelding with spring goals in mind.


