Champagne popped as Castelveccchio lands first Group 1 win for Litt

Juvenile colt also achieves milestone for young sire Dundee with Randwick victory

Richard Litt was savouring the biggest success of his short career after talented colt Castelveccchio produced a dominant performance in yesterday's ATC Champagne Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m), the first Australian elite level win for his exciting young sire Dundee (High Chaparral).

The Warwick Farm-based trainer, 29, has been patient in the handling of Castelveccchio, bypassing the Golden

Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) instead choosing to turn his focus on yesterday's \$500,000 Randwick feature.

Jockey Josh Parr settled Castelveccchio in a midfield position, eventually coming home strongly to overhaul the favourite Loving Gaby (I Am Invincible) to beat the filly by one and a half lengths, with the winner clocking a slick time of 1:33.31 seconds (last 600 metres in 35.50 seconds).

The Danny O'Brien-trained Lady Lupino (Sebring) was another three-quarters of a length back in third. *Continued on page 2 >>*

Pierata (Pierro) has all but secured his place as a stallion after adding an important Group 1 victory to his CV with a win in yesterday's All Aged Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Randwick.

Three times-placed at Group 1 level prior to his breakthrough Randwick success, Pierata's trainer Greg Hickman and the entire's owners have resisted offers from studs over the past 12 months and their patience will no doubt have paid off, with his value set to have skyrocketed after yesterday's win.

Beaten a "pixel" in The Galaxy (Gr 1, 1100m) in March before a last-start fifth to Santa Ana Lane (Lope De Vega) in the TJ Smith Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m), Pierata finished a long-neck ahead of Osborne Bulls, who was second for the fourth time at Group 1 level this preparation. Siege Of Quebec (Fastnet Rock) was another half a length away in third. *Racing News page 4 >*

Castelvechio signaled his ability by coming from last to win his first start at Canterbury in January, before landing the \$2 million Inglis Millennium (RL, 1200m) on his next start.

The colt then finished third in the Skyline Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) and filled the same position in the Inglis Sires' Produce Stakes (registered as ATC Sires' Produce Stakes) (Gr 1, 1400m) earlier in the month.

"It's huge. It's a feeling I've never had," Litt said.

"It's been a great preparation in. We would have loved to have won the Sires' but that didn't happen and coming two weeks into this we had great confidence he would run well.

"There were no moments where we've ever doubted ourselves. We've gone straight on and done our job.

"He'll improve out of sight as a three-year-old. He is only a small horse and has a lot of maturing to do."

Parr said: "I'm thrilled. Right now I'm really buzzing. The writing has been on the wall for some time that the Champagne Stakes was his mark, the 1600 metres at Randwick.

"There is still a lot there. He's only just learning his craft now. He was able to jump into a midfield position, travel like the winner the entire way and won like a very good horse.

"The job Richie has done with this horse has been remarkable.

"He has been able to keep him up and have him peak on the day."

Arrowfield Stud principal John Messara was behind a large-scale investment to purchase Dundee for stud duties while the son of High

Chaparral (Sadler's Wells) was still racing and he was delighted with the rise of sire and Castelvechio, who was purchased by Ottavio and Wendy Galletta for \$150,000 at the 2018 Inglis Classic Yearling Sale from the Arrowfield Stud draft.

"It's a great thrill. This horse Castelvechio is really taking it all in front of him and so is his sire Dundee," Messara said.

"That's three Group 1 winners for Dundee now across the world – one in New Zealand, one in South Africa and now one here in Australia. He's an amazing animal.

"I think he's done enough now to satisfy us" Continued on page 4>>



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<< *Continued from page 2* that he's going to be a leading force in this country for the next decade or so. That means a lot to us, especially with the loss of Redoute's.

"Castelvechio was always a very nice type. Ottavio had a look around our farm at all our yearlings and he got it down to a couple of horses and finally selected this one. He made the right call."

James McDonald rode the Ciaron Maher and David Eustace-trained Loving Gaby, with the jockey predicting a bright future for the filly who was also placed in the ATC Sires' Produce Stakes and ran fourth in the Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m).

"She's come a long way in a short period of time," McDonald said.

"It's a real credit to the Maher and Eustace stable and also a credit to her. She's a very good filly and she's only going to get better from here on in."

Castelvechio (2 c Dundee - St Therese by Dehere) has now won three of his five starts, finishing third in the other two which has seen him earn \$1,608,000 prize-money.

Castelvechio is one of 11 named foals, and is the fifth winner from eight foals to have raced out of the Listed-winning and Group 2-placed Dehere (Deputy Minister) mare St. Therese.

St Therese is also the dam of Spring Champion Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) winner Maid Of Heaven (Smart Missile) and Group 3 winner Mirrasalo (Redoute's Choice).

Furthermore, St. Therese is out of the four-time winner Moon Scent

(Aloe), a prolific producer whose talents as a broodmare have been best advertised by 17-time winner Planet Ruler (Kaoru Star), who secured four successes at Group 1 level amongst a glowing career record.

St Therese has a yearling colt by Panzer Division (Redoute's Choice) and is due to foal this August to the same sire.

Dundee (High Chaparral), who stood for a fee of \$27,500 (inc GST) last year, is the sire of seven individual stakes winners including Manawatu Sires' Produce Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) winner Yourdeel and Cape Derby (Gr 1, 2000m) winner Atyaab.

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<< *Continued from page 4* the TJ Smith Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m), Pierata finished a long-neck ahead of Osborne Bulls, who was second for the fourth time at Group 1 level this preparation. Siege Of Quebec (Fastnet Rock) was another half a length away in third.

"We've been knocking on the door for so long," Hickman said.

"He's been running the sectionals and in his work you could see he's been improving in his coat and attitude.

"A horse like this is life changing. I've got a little share in him which will help along the way and Tommy [Berry] rode him ten out of ten."

Berry said, once Pierata settled in a midfield position, he was confident the four-year-old would once again be right in the finish of a Group 1.

"He travelled so sweetly for me in the run. At the top of the rise on the better going he was able to let down with that signature turn of foot he has got," Berry said.

"I thought Osborne Bulls was going to get me at the 100 [metres] but my bloke actually pulled away from him late.

"He deserved to win. He is a quality colt and I'm sure there will be a lot of studs knocking on the door now.

"The owners are passionate. They've stuck by Greg which is incredible when they could have sold him off a long time ago. Full credit to these guys."

Berry and his late twin brother Nathan, who was also a jockey, spent their childhoods around the stables at Warwick Farm until they were old enough to ride.

"They've always been there," Hickman said.

"Nathan rode his first black-type winner on Rubinda for me.

"Now Tommy has won a Group 1. Mum and dad have been great supporters behind the scenes and we are all pretty close."

Berry also took great satisfaction out of riding a Group 1 winner for Hickman: "Greg is like family to us. I grew up with him and used to call him Cowboy when we were growing up," he said.

"It is very special. I've always remembered where I come from and I love riding for the trainers out there.

"You know how hard these guys work but they don't get the credit they deserve."

Osborne Bulls' jockey Hugh Bowman said: "Well he's a model of consistency and he hasn't let anyone down again."

Tim Clark said the firm Randwick track (rated a Good 4), in which fast times were being recorded, helped Siege Of Quebec produce a much-improved performance.

"He ran out of skin, back on a dry track at WFA level, I was really proud of his performance," he said,

Purchased by Hickman for \$160,000 at the 2016 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale from the Kitchwin Hills draft, the Hobartville Stud-bred Pierata (4 h Pierro - November Flight by Flying Spur) has won seven races, five of which have been at stakes level, from 19 starts for prize-money earnings of \$3,311,300.

Pierata is one of four winners for Group 3 winner November Flight, who has also produced Group 3 winner and Group 1-placed Ashokan (More Than Ready)

The yearling half-brother to Pierata by Pierro's barnmate Rubick (Encosta De Lago) was purchased by Coolmore's Tom Magnier and Ciaran Maher Bloodstock for \$900,000 at the Inglis Australain Easter Yearling Sale earlier this month.

She is due to foal to Pierro again this October.

The Coolmore Stud-based Pierro is the sire of 16 individual stakes winners with Pierata joining Arcadia Queen, Levendi and Pinot as the Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winning stallion's other top-level winners.

Pierro will stand for unchanged fee of \$88,000 (inc GST) in 2019.



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Tough Group 3 winner Laburnum another shining light for Denman

Twin Hills Stud's Olly Tait's play for Darley sire Denman (Lonhro) appears set to pay off, after his daughter Laburnum landed the JHB Carr Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) at Randwick yesterday, becoming the son of Lonhro's (Octagonal) 15th overall stakes winner, and second in as many weeks.

The Darley homebred's win also continued the sustained run of success this autumn for Godolphin and head trainer James Cummings with the filly having finished eighth to stablemate Multaja (Medaglia d'Oro) in the PJ Bell Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) at her previous start.

She held off the late burst of race favourite Into The Abyss (Foxwedge) by a nose with a long head back to So Taken (Street Boss).

It was announced last week that Denman would relocate from Darley's Kelvinside stud to Tait's growing Cootamundra operation where he will stand at \$8,800 (inc GST).

Laburnum's Group 3 win comes after Denman's other daughter Humma Humma took out the Redelva Stakes (Listed, 1100m) at Morphettville last week.

Laburnum ran seventh behind Fiesta (I Am Invincible) in the Silver Shadow Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) last spring but Cummings has taken a conservative approach with the filly this campaign.

"She has done a wonderful job this preparation. [She was] placed in the Canberra Guineas and we got her confidence back at the provincials," Cummings said.

"After a tough run in the PJ Bell she was geared up to run a bold race from a forward position.

"She has been able to sustain the preparation. We've got no fear of keeping her in training for longer. We have reaped the rewards for that. She is a Group 3 winner now."

Kathy O'Hara picked up the ride on Laburnum after Glyn Schofield was ruled out of the meeting due to injury and she was suitably impressed with the filly's Group 3 win yesterday.

"She hasn't had a huge amount of luck in her runs but even going to the start she is a free striding mare, she was a little keen on the bridle for me," O'Hara said.

"But she had a good kick and held on well."

Damian Lane, who rode the John Thompson-trained Into The Abyss, said: "She ran well, what can you say?"

Kerrin McEvoy said the outside barrier (13) had proven a disadvantage for third-placed So Taken.

"(It was a) great run, but the barrier just had us riding her a bit conservative," he said. "A better barrier and she's winning today, so that's disappointing."

Laburnum (3 f Denman - Runes by Redoute's Choice) has won three of her 14 career starts with another six placings and prize-money earnings of \$213,620.

She is the only named foal for Runes, who was a city-placed winner who is a sister to the Group 3 winner Mearas and a half-sister to the Group 3-winning sprinter Chetwood (Exceed And Excel).

Purchased for \$240,000 by Corumbene Stud at the 2016 Magic Millions Gold Coast National Broodmare Sale, Runes has a weanling filly by Darley's Shooting To Win (Northern Meteor) and was covered by Newgate Farm's young sire Dissident (Sebring) last October.

Meanwhile, Denman, who covered 95 mares in 2018, is also the sire of Hong Kong Group 2 winner Hot King Prawn and Group 2 winners Fitocracy and Whiskey Neat, a promising juvenile in New Zealand this season.

Derby Consolation gained by Baker and Forsman's The Chosen One

The Chosen One (Savabeel) gained compensation for New Zealand co-trainers Murray Baker and Andrew Forsman with an authoritative victory in the Frank Packer Plate (Gr 3, 2000m) at Randwick yesterday, providing the duo with an across-the-Tasman stakes race treble.

The three-year-old colt was forced to endure the widest passage of all when a creditable fourth in the Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) earlier in the Sydney Carnival, but enjoyed better fortune on his second Australian outing yesterday when striding clear of the pack to beat Dealmaker (Dundeel) by a length and a half, with Purple Sector (Pins) a further head adrift in third.

Despite The Chosen One's impressive victory - his second at Group 3 level having taken out the Manawatu Classic (Gr 3, 2000m) prior to his Derby fourth - Forsman said the team would not be tempted by the Brisbane Winter Carnival, with the colt set to be aimed at bigger targets in the spring.

"He has been up a long time but he keeps improving," Forsman said.

"He's a quality-bred colt, just maturing at the right time. It was great to see him get his just desserts today.

"Brisbane would be tempting but hopefully he's got bigger fish to fry in the spring. You can't do it everywhere.

"We had two big runs in the Derby and hadn't had a winner in the carnival, but they raced well enough so it was good to get the result today."

Winning jockey Blake Shinn was another rueing what could have been in the Derby, though he could not hide his delight at gaining restitution for Baker and Forsman who had struck earlier in the day courtesy of Quick Thinker (So You Think) and Lord Arthur's (Camelot) stakes victories at Ellerslie.

"It is a consolation for the Derby," he said. "The Derby was a little bit frustrating, we were the victim of a wide barrier and had to take him back.

"I thought his run was arguably the best run in the race and he brought that form here today.

"We made another searching run on him but we were coming back 400 metres so I was mindful of that.

"He is a lovely horse and it is great to win for Murray Baker and Andrew. It is my first winner for them so hopefully it is the start of a good association."

Passed in for NZ\$1500,000 at the 2017 NZB National Yearling Sale, The Chosen One (3 c Savabeel - The Glitzy One by Flying Spur) is the only foal to race out of the eight-time winner The Glitzy One (Flying Spur), who also recorded a number of placings at stakes level during her 44-start career.

The Glitzy One is herself a daughter of New Zealand champion three-year-old and dual Group 1 winner The Jewel (O'Reilly), making her a half-sister to Group 3 winner The Diamond One (Tale Of The Cat) and the stakes-performed duo The Precious One (Darci Brahma) and The Bold One (Fastnet Rock).

Further back this is also the family of New Zealand One Thousand Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) winner La Bella Diosa (So You Think), Auckland Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) winner Irish Chance (Sir Tristram) and New Zealand horse of the year The Phantom (Noble Bijou).

The Chosen One is one of 89 stakes winners for Waikato Stud-based sire Savabeel (Zabeel), who is currently at the top of the New Zealand's leading sires table, by both winners and earnings. Savabeel had two lots sell for an aggregate of \$1,010,000 at the Inglis Australian Easter Yearling earlier in the month.

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Four for Pierro

Coolmore Stud's Pierro (Lonhro) sired his fourth Group 1 winner courtesy of Pierata's (4 h ex November Flight by Flying Spur) victory in the All Aged Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Randwick yesterday. The Greg Hickman-trained four-year-old was purchased for \$160,000 at the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale from the Kitchwin Hills draft and has now won \$3,311,300 in career prize-money. Pierro's other Group 1 scorers are Pinot, Levendi and Arcadia Queen, and he will stand at Coolmore for a fee of \$88,000 (inc GST) this season.

Three for Dundee

Ever consistent colt Castelvechio (2 c ex St Therese by Dehere) finally broke through at elite level yesterday in impressive fashion, taking the Champagne Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) at Randwick and in the process providing Arrowfield Stud's progressive sire Dundee (High Chaparral) with his third Group / Grade 1 winner. Purchased by Galletta Constructions Co from the Arrowfield Stud draft for \$150,000 at the Inglis Classic Yearling Sale, the Richard Litt-trained colt had been knocking on the door at elite level, including running third in the Inglis Sires' (Gr 1, 1400m) this month. Castelvechio joins fellow juvenile winner Yourdeel and Cape Derby (Gr 1, 2000m) winner Atyaab as the stallion's other elite level winners.

290 for Galileo

Coolmore Stud stalwart Galileo (Sadler's Wells) brought up his 290th stakes winner after his son Grey Lion (7 g ex Grey Lilas by Danehill) won the Japan Racing Association Plate (Gr 3, 2000m) at Randwick yesterday. The Matthew Smith-trained seven-year-old gelding finished strongly to beat Emperor's Way (Roman Emperor) by a length and a quarter, with the same distance back to All Too Soon (All Too Hard) in third. Originally trained in France, Grey Lion won his first Australian race for Victorian trainer Matt Cumani at Randwick in July after which owners OTI Racing decided to transfer him to Smith at Warwick Farm to continue his racing in Sydney.

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15 for Denman

Grey Lion was ridden to victory by Kathy O'Hara and she brought up the first leg of a Group 3 double aboard Laburnum (3 f ex Runes by Redoute's Choice) in the JHB Carr Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) at Randwick yesterday, a victory that provided Twin Hills' new stallion Denman (Lonhro) with his 15th stakes winner. The three-year-old filly is out of the winning Redoute's Choice (Danehill) mare Runes, who is herself a sister to Group 3 winner Mearas and a three-quarters sister to fellow Group 3 winner Chetwood (Exceed And Excel). Redoute's Choice enjoyed a great day as a broodmare sire, strengthening his lead at the top of the Australia's leading broodmare sire championship, which he looks well on course to win for the first time in August.

Trekking returns to winning groove

Having not saluted the judge since his victory in the Testa Rossa Stakes (Listed, 1200m) back in September, the James Cummings-trained Trekking (4 g Street Cry - Outdoor by Redoute's Choice) returned to winning ways in the Hall Mark Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) at Randwick yesterday. The four-year-old gelding stayed on stoutly to defeat Brave Song (Your Song) by a long neck, with a neck back to Redouble (Redoute's Choice) in third. "With the patience of waiting for today on the dry, he was able to get his heart rate down turning for home and really let go for Kerrin unleashing that sprint," Cummings said. "We'll talk to Kerrin [McEvoy] about Brisbane because the options are there. He's got more to offer."

Eight for Mamool

Plein Ciel (6 g ex Picobella by Big Shuffle) landed his first stakes race and first victory for new trainer Anthony Freedman since his transfer from disqualified trainer Darren Weir when running out a ready winner of the Easter Cup (Gr 3, 2000m) at Caulfield. The six-year-old gelding beat Furrion (Camelot) by a length with another quarter of a length back to Morton's Fork (Ad Valorem) in third and in the process handed Mamool (In The Wings) his eighth stakes winner.

More relaxed Plein Ciel pleases Freedman

Anthony Freedman said a lot of work had gone into getting the German import to relax ahead of yesterday's Group 3 contest. "He would get quite hot at the races but he's started to settle down each run and today was the best he's presented I thought," Freedman said. "He's worked it all out now, so we'll see where that leads us. I think he's running out of races in Melbourne and I don't think there's a lot for him in Adelaide, so it's probably Brisbane or a rest and we'll make a call on that in a week or so. He's a good honest horse that was in his right grade today. He got a lovely run and we probably dodged a bullet on the corner (when Magnapal went amiss) and then he was strong all the way to the line. All his runs have been good and I thought he was ready for the 2000 metres."

Streets Of Avalon bounces back

Having disappointed on his most recent appearance at Caulfield, the Shane Nichols-trained Streets Of Avalon (4 g Magnus - Kamuniak by Black Minnaloushe) bounced back to form to land yesterday's Victoria Handicap (Gr 3, 1400m) at the Melbourne track. The four-year-old gelding won the Hareeba Stakes (Listed, 1200m) two starts ago and he added a second stakes race to his CV with his narrow defeat of Manolo Blahniq (Jimmy Choux), coming home a half-neck in front of the gelding, with Fastnet Tempest (Fastnet Rock) another length and three quarters adrift in third. Nichols said the gelding would likely be aimed at Group 1 races in the Spring, with the trainer earmarking the Sir Rupert Clarke Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) and Toorak Handicap (Gr 1, 1600m) as possible future targets.

Clayton Douglas lands first Group win

Streets Of Avalon's win in the Victoria Handicap also handed jockey Clayton Douglas with his first Group victory. "This is my first Group winner. I've had a couple of placings before so it's good to get the monkey off the back," Douglas said. "It's massive. I've been working

really hard and I've been wanting this to happen for a while. I can't thank the owners and Shane enough. I've worked for Shane for a long time now and for him to give me this opportunity, and for me to get the job done is a bit of a proud moment."

SA Derby the plan for Grinzing Star

Following Grinzing Star's (Reliable Man) victory in the Bill Collins Handicap (2000m) at Caulfield yesterday, Danny O'Brien is now eyeing a tilt at the South Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2500m) for the gelding. The three-year-old beat Makybe Diva's (Desert King) daughter Divanation (All Too Hard) by a length with Birth Of Venus (High Chaparral) another nose away in third. "He will run again in a fortnight at Flemington over 2000 metres and then he will potentially back up into the South Australian Derby a week later," O'Brien said. "He needs another run at 2000 metres. He's a very robust horse and the seven-day back-up would be perfect going to a mile and a half after that. He was gelded at the end of the spring and that was his first racing preparation. He's definitely a more seasoned racehorse now."

Princess Jenni to Australasian Oaks

Princess Jenni (High Chaparral) could also be heading to South Australia, with trainer David Brideoake penciling in a crack at the Schweppes Oaks (registered as Australasian Oaks) (Gr 1, 2000m) at Morphettville on May 4 after the filly's win in the Jack Elliot Handicap (1600m) at Caulfield yesterday. Princess Jenni was dropping back in class yesterday having won the Alexandra Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m) at Moonee Valley last month and was scratched from the Adrian Knox Stakes (Gr 3, 2000m) at Randwick on April 6 after Racing NSW stewards held suspicions the filly had received illegal raceday treatment. Ridden by Damien Oliver, Princess Jenni scored a short-half-head win over Sure Knee (Snitzel) with Collectable (Sebring) two and three quarter lengths away third.

83 for Lonhro

The ever-popular Darley stallion Lonhro (Octagonal) sired his 83rd stakes winner after the James Cummings-trained Plague Stone (3 g ex Giggleswick by Elusive Quality) won the Mick Dittman Plate (Listed, 1110m) at Doomben yesterday. The three-year-old gelding, who had not won a race since his victory in the Rosebud Prelude 2YO Handicap (1000m), comprehensively beat Vega One (Lope De Vega) by three and three quarter lengths with Spirit's Choice (Spirit Of Boom) another long neck away in third. Lonhro will stand at Darley's Kelvinside base in New South Wales this year for \$77,000 (inc GST), having stood last season for \$55,000 (inc GST).

Gold Coast Guineas next for Plague Stone

Following Plague Stone's win yesterday, Godolphin stable representative Nacim Dilmi said the gelding would return to Sydney and then come back north for the Gold Coast Guineas (Gr 3, 1200m) on May 4. The gelding will then press on into the winter stakes races. "We have always known he had the ability and this is his chance to show it," said Dilmi. "It was a strong win today and he is on the right track."

Three for Love Conquers All

The Sun Stud-based stallion Love Conquers All (Mossman) was yesterday provided with his third stakes winner following Mr Marbellouz's (5 g ex Marbled by Red Ransom) win in the Ascot Handicap (Listed, 1200m) at Doomben. Last seen running eighth in the TC Weetwood Handicap (Listed, 1200m), the Kevin Kemp-trained gelding prevailed in a close finish to beat Sony Legend (Hard Spun)

by a nose, with another length and a half back to No Annamossity (Mossman) in third. Mr Marbellouz joins Group 2 winner Savanna Amour and Group 3 scorer I'm A Rippa as Love Conquers All's other stakes winners.

Two for Tosen Phantom

Japanese sire Tosen Phantom (Neo Universe) was handed his second stakes winner yesterday after Hallelujah Boy (6 g ex Tosen Minerva by King Kamehameha) ran out a convincing winner of the Tails Stakes (Listed, 1615m) at Doomben. The Kris Lees-trained Hallelujah Boy set a lackadaisical pace and then came away in the straight to beat Cool Chap (High Chaparral) by two and three quarter lengths, with a quarter of a length to Fit For Purpose (Show A Heart) in third. Tosen Phantom's other stakes winner is Brave Smash, who will cover his first book of mares at Aquis Farm in 2019.

Wayne Wilson Memorial Mile the plan for Hallelujah Boy

Kris Lees' stable representative Mel Eggleston said after Hallelujah Boy's win at Doomben that the gelding could now head to The Wayne Wilson (Listed, 1600m) at Eagle Farm on June 8. "I would love to win a race like the Wayne Wilson Memorial Mile next month. But really he would need a wet track to be competitive with some of the better horses," Eggleston said. "But for all that I thought he was close to a good thing today. He loves wet tracks and he was the only pace in the race. I told Matt (jockey McGillivray) to lead and set the pace before kicking away on the turn. It turned out perfectly."

Despatch lands Oakbank Stakes

The Tony McEvoy-trained Despatch (4 g Written Tycoon - Zoccoletta by Fasliyev) proved too strong for his rivals in the Oakbank Stakes (Listed, 1100m) yesterday. This was the second win at stakes level for the four-year-old gelding, having won the Phelan Ready Stakes (Listed, 1110m) in December 2016 and he sealed his second black-type win with a quarter length victory over Zalmona (Good Journey), with Crown Fontein (Turffontein) three quarters of a length away in third. Despatch is one of 28 stakes winners for

Woodside Park's stallion Written Tycoon (Iglesia), who will stand this season for an unchanged fee of \$110,000 (inc GST).

Nine for Deep Field

Newgate Farm-based sire Deep Field (Northern Meteor) continued to make waves with his first crop, siring his ninth winner yesterday in the shape of Mocambo (2 c ex Lady Bligh by Redoute's Choice), who won the Charge of Beersheba Maiden 2YO Handicap (1400m) at Kembla Grange. Having finished fifth on debut over 1000 metres, the Allan Denham-trained colt clearly appreciated the step in distance, beating Cock Match (Zoffany) by a decisive length and a half with another two lengths to Shining Eagle (Verrazzano) in third. Deep Field's first crop of winners include Group 2 winner Dig Deep and Group 3 winner Cosmic Force.

First for Hallowed Crown

The Stuart Kendrick-trained Let's Cheer Again (2 c ex Excessively by Exceed And Excel) yesterday provided Darley first season sire Hallowed Crown (Street Sense) with his first winner. The colt, who was bred by Gerry Harvey and sold for \$85,000 at last year's Magic Millions Gold Coast 2YOs in Training Sale, led throughout in the TAB QTIS 2YO Colts and Geldings Maiden Plate (900m) at the Gold Coast to defeat Poetic Choice (Poet's Voice) and Iced (Better Than Ready). Hallowed Crown, who won the 2015 Randwick Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m), will stand at Darley's Kelvinside property this year for a fee of \$11,000 (inc GST).

13 for Snippetson

Tinsnip (2 g ex Mabel Grace by Kendel Star) on Friday provided his now Western Australian-based sire Snippetson (Snippets) with his 13th stakes winner when the juvenile scored a breakthrough win in the WA Sires' Produce Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) at Ascot. The Adam Durrant-trained two-year-old had been placed at three of his previous five starts, including finishing runner-up in the Karrakatta Plate (Gr 2, 1200m), before winning by a nose on Friday. Specialism (Safeguard) was second, with Kelvin (Heritage) another length and a quarter away in third place. Snippetson, who stands at Scenic Lodge, is the sire of Group 2 winners Fast Clip and My Poppeette and four Group 3 winners.

Sixth stakes win for Celebrity Dream

The Bob and Sandra Peters-owned mare Celebrity Dream (Thorn Park) scored her sixth stakes win and 11th overall at Ascot on Friday when she took out the Sheila Gwynne Classic (Listed, 1400m). The Adam Durrant-trained six-year-old, who has won at Group 3 level, defeated Classic Pro (Proart) by a length and a half, with Lady Cosmology (Universal Ruler) another nose away in third. Celebrity Dream has earned \$618,550 in prize-money from 27 starts.

Last two races postponed at Doomben

Stewards abandoned the final two races at the Doomben meeting after they found there were risks with visibility following rain falling all afternoon. The Princess Stakes (Listed, 1600m) will now be run at Caloundra at 5.27pm and the field and barriers will be the same. After race seven, the Mick Dittman Plate, senior jockeys Jeff Lloyd and Matt McGillivray went to stewards and raised concerns about the track. "We spoke with all 10 jockeys who rode in the Dittman Plate and four said they would ride on but would go with the majority," Lloyd said. "The problem is the kick back and some jockey can't see." Meanwhile, the Gold Coast race meeting was also called off after race four of the nine-race card.

Fall costs Kayla Crowther 15 meeting ban

Apprentice Kayla Crowther has been suspended for 15 meetings for careless riding after her mount fell at Caulfield. Crowther was aboard Latin Beat (Galileo) in the Bill Collins Handicap (2000m) when the gelding fell approximately 150 metres from the finish. She pleaded guilty to the charge, with RV chief steward Robert Cram describing the incident "in the upper echelon of careless riding". Dwayne Dunn was also suspended for 10 meetings after pleading guilty to careless riding aboard Manolo Blahniq (Jimmy Choux), while John Allen was outed for nine meetings for causing interference on eventual winner Grey Shadow (Dash For Cash) early in the Noel Rundle Handicap (1100m).

New Zealand

14 for Camelot

The Murray Baker and Andrew Forsman-trained Lord Arthur (3g ex Imposingly by Zabeel) showed marked improvement to run out a taking winner of the Championship Stakes (Gr 2, 2100m) at Ellerslie yesterday, providing former Coolmore Stud shuttler Camelot (Montjeu) with his 14th stakes winner. The gelding drew a length and a half clear under Jake Bayliss to beat Intrigue (Showcasing), with a further two lengths back to Bobby Dee (Zed) in third. The regally-bred Lord Arthur is a half-brother to multiple Group 1 winner Bonneval (Makfi), Group 3 winners Imposing Lass (Makfi), Full Of Spirit (Flying Spur) and Lady Cumquot (Duke Of Marmalade). Camelot is currently standing at Coolmore Stud in Ireland for a fee of €40,000 and shuttled to Australia for one season in 2014.

Brisbane a possibility for Lord Arthur

Co-trainer Murray Baker has said the gelding was a slow maturer so was happy to have seen him win his first stakes race yesterday and was now considering taking him over to Australia for the Brisbane Spring Carnival. "That was very impressive," Baker said. "He's a half to Bonneval who has been a little bit immature. We've spaced his races and given him plenty of time. I gave him a stayer's show today with plenty of pace on. He showed good acceleration. He's been a bit weak, but he's started to get it together in the last month or so. There is a possibility he could go on to Brisbane from here."

Breakthrough NZ win for Endless Drama

Talented Irish import Endless Drama (6 c Lope de Vega - Desert Drama by Green Desert) recorded his first victory on New Zealand soil when showing a smart turn of foot to land the Easter Handicap (Gr 2, 1600m) at Ellerslie yesterday. Formerly trained by Chris Waller having moved from Ger Lyons in 2016, the entire was having his third start for Tony Pike and readily beat Watch This Space (Elusive City) by a long neck, with Yearn (Savabeel) a further three quarters of a length adrift in third. Endless Drama is one of 52 stakes winner for former Patinack Farm-shuttler Lope De Vega (Shamardal), who stands at Ballylinch Stud in Ireland for a career-high fee of €80,000.

Patient path pays off for Pike

Tony Pike admitted he had taken a patient path with Endless Drama as the horse had shown some symptoms of niggling issues from the general wear and tear of his career to date. "He's just got a little bit of a wind issue being an older horse," Pike said. "He's quite a big, gross, heavy horse and just ridden that little bit quieter means he can get in a better rhythm and show that turn of foot. I was lucky enough to train for Qatar Bloodstock some years back now and when the horse failed at Otaki, Chris (Waller) said to them he was probably better placed here rather than go back to Sydney. They left him here and the change of environment with an older horse has really improved him."

17 for So You Think

Coolmore stallion So You Think (High Chaparral) was provided with his 17th stakes winner courtesy of Quick Thinker's (2 c ex Acouplamas by Al Maher) impressive victory in the Champagne Stakes (Listed, 1600m) at Ellerslie yesterday. The Murray Baker and Andrew Forsman-trained colt improved significantly from his debut second at Rotorua earlier this month to score by three quarters of a length, with Ranger (Ghibellines) getting the better of Rendition (Pierro) by half a length in the battle for second and third. The OTI-raced filly was purchased by De Burgh Equine for \$100,000 at the Inglis Classic Yearling Sale from the Coolmore Stud draft. So You Think will stand for a fee of \$38,500 (inc GST) this season, having stood for \$44,000 (inc GST) in 2018 and he has one lot catalogued for next month's Karaka May Sale. Lil Miss Swiss (5 m ex Miss Swiss by Flying Spur) made her first start at stakes level a winning one when taking out the Riverton Cup (Listed, 2147m) yesterday by the narrowest of margins. The five-year-old mare got the better of Orepuki Lad (Raise The Flag) by a nose, with Kilowatt (Shocking) two and a quarter lengths behind the pair in third. The Kelvin Tyler-trained Lil Miss Swiss's victory provided Windsor Park Stud stallion Rip Van Winkle (Galileo) with his 26th stakes winner, while the son of Galileo (Sadler's Wells) is set to be represented by five lots at next month's Karaka May Sale. Champion two-year-old Too Darn Hot (Dubawi) has been ruled out of the 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1m), for which he was ante-post favourite, after John Gosden revealed the colt had not recovered from the injury which saw him miss last week's Greenham Stakes (Gr 3, 7f). While he will miss the first Classic of the season, Gosden is hoping to get the Group 1-winning colt back on a racetrack for the Dante Stakes (Gr 2, 1m2f) at York or the Irish 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1m). "Although he has shown great improvement in the last nine days, Too Darn Hot will not be ready in time to run in the 2,000 Guineas," said Gosden. "It's unfortunate but it's only two weeks away and that does not allow us sufficient time to get the required work into him. Consequently he'll miss Newmarket."

60 for Mastercraftsman

Last year's Sandringham Stakes (1m) winner Agrotera (4 f ex Lombatina by King's Best) made a winning return to the track in the Snowdrop Fillies' Stakes (Listed, 1m) at Kempton yesterday and in the process provided former shuttler Mastercraftsman (Danehill Dancer) with his 60th stakes winner. The Ed Walker-trained four-year-old, who was sent off the 7/2 favourite, finished strongly to beat Preening (Dutch Art) by a length with another three quarters of a length back to Rawdaa (Teofilo) in third. Owned and bred by Bjorn Nielsen, Agrotera has now won three of her eight career starts, which has seen her earn £100,982 in career prize-money. Former Windsor Park Stud shuttler, Mastercraftsman now stands exclusively at Coolmore Stud in Ireland for a fee of €30,000 and his progeny is headed by 12 Group 1 winners.

Two for American Pharoah

Coolmore Stud shuttler American Pharoah (Pioneerof The Nile) was provided with his second winner from just his third runner when Maven (2 c ex Richies Party Girl by Any Given Saturday) made just about all to land the Maiden Special Weight (4.5f) at Aqueduct yesterday. Trained and bred by Wesley Ward and ridden by Dylan Davis, the juvenile beat

Lebda (Raison d'Etat) by half a length, with the pair pulling 11 and a quarter lengths clear of Analyze Your Risk (Overanalyze) in third. The colt's victory was made even more impressive, given he is a late foal having been born on May 24. The Chad Brown-trained Electric Forest (4 f ex Forest Music by Unbridled's Song) showed a game attitude to run out a gutsy winner of the Doubledogdare Stakes (Gr 3, 8.5f) at Keeneland on Friday, providing Hill 'N' Dale Farm-based stallion Curlin (Smart Strike) with his 59th stakes winner in the process.
