Inglis release catalogue for The Chairman's Sale

Hutch looking forward to sale which will appeal to everyone

Inglis have released the catalogue for their upcoming boutique sale, The Chairman's Sale, which will see 51 elite mares go under the hammer at Riverside Stables on May 3.

The auction house's breeding series sale has been subject to a significant change in terms of timetabling, with the select weanlings and general weanlings set to be conducted on May 3 and The Chairman's Sale now taking place on the Friday night, after the first session of the select broodmares. The rest of the

fillies and broodmares offered as part of the Australian Broodmare and Weanling Sale will be offered on May 6.

The mares likely to take centre stage at The Chairman's Sale have been well documented by Inglis in the run-up to the catalogue release, with Group 1 winners Aloisia (Azamour) (**Lot 34**), Pasadena Girl (Savabeel) (**Lot 18**), Norzita (Thorn Park) (**Lot 16**) and Srikanthi (**Lot 28**), whose filly by I Am invincible (Invincible Spirit) will be offered during the weanling session of the Australian Broodmare and Weanling Sale. All four lots are set to be offered on the Friday night.

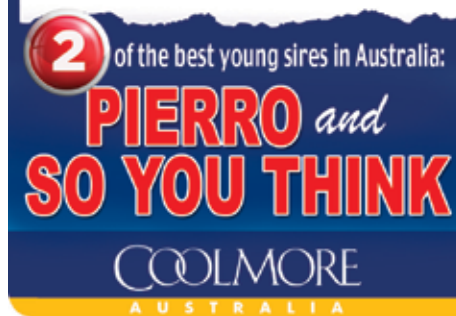

Sidestep covered covered 57 mares at a fee of \$7,700 (inc GST) in Australia last year - his first season standing at Telemon Thoroughbreds having previously shuttled for Darley.

The Chairman's Sale is enhanced even further by the proven broodmares set to go through the ring. They include Now Now (Danehill Dancer) (**Lot 17**), the dam of Group 2 winner Fiesta (I Am Invincible), whose colt by Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m)-winning first season sire Capitalist (Written Tycoon) will also be offered during the weanling session of the Australian Broodmare and Weanling Sale. Another intriguing entry is Noondie (Flying Spur) (**Lot 15**), whose daughter Booker (Written Tycoon) added the Oakleigh Plate (Gr 1, 1100m) to her CV last month.

Sebastian Hutch, who joined Inglis as their general manager of bloodstock sales in October from Coolmore Stud, told ANZ Bloodstock News that the bloodstock team had made a conscious effort to include a variety of mares within the boutique catalogue.

"We are delighted with the way the book has come together," he said. "As a bloodstock team, we put a huge amount of work into identifying what we consider to be appropriate mares for a boutique sale and we have tried to be selective about it.

"We wanted to get elite producers and elite-race fillies and we feel like we have managed to secure a number of those. But then we were also trying to identify pedigrees that would appeal to people both domestically and internationally.

"There are some young mares in there carrying some very valuable pregnancies, being in foal to the most commercially-desirable stallions, not just in Australia but in the world. We felt it important that we were able

to secure mares who were carrying such pregnancies and I feel we have done that.

Hutch continued: "All-in-all we are very excited about the prospect of the sale. Obviously there is a lot of work to do to ensure that all of the appropriate investors are present and correct, but the feedback up to this point has been hugely positive and hugely encouraging.

"We are very grateful for the support we've had from a variety of different people - owners, vendors etc."

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<< *Continued from page 2* to a global market, which will no doubt be significantly bolstered by the fact that Inglis announced The Chairman's Sale will include a zero per cent sales commission on race fillies and broodmares.

"Historically the market is underpinned by domestic investors, but we will be working hard to solicit the attention of the international market as well," he said. "The marketplace in Australia is a very cosmopolitan one and we are not ignorant of that fact.

"We wanted to put something together where people turn the page and think: 'I want that mare, I like that filly, I like the idea of that pregnancy.' There are obviously a multitude of reasons why people go to broodmare sales looking to source particular stock, and every breeder has a different agenda, but we are looking to try and satisfy as many of those criterias as we possibly can.

The Chairman's Sale will begin on a poignant note, with a nomination to Widden Stud's new sire, four-time Group 1 winner Trapeze Artist (Snitzel), for the 2019 Australian breeding season set to go under the hammer. All proceeds of the sale will go to injured jockey Tye Angland, who rode the colt to three of those elite-level successes.

"Obviously the unfortunate circumstances around Tye Angland's accident have been well documented," said Hutch. "He was not only a hugely-popular jockey, but a hugely-popular member of the industry more broadly.

"The gesture on the part of Mr and Mrs Viera to support Tye and his family is a very gracious one and we are delighted to be able to take that

as part of the sale. Naturally, we are hopeful that it will prove a hugely-popular offering."

The other stallion offering is one share in the Russian Revolution (Snitzel) stallion syndicate, which is likely to be much-coveted given it entitles the owner to two nominations per season to the Newgate Farm sire until 2021 and one nomination per season thereafter.

Hutch was not downplaying the interest he expected this lot to garner.

"Russian Revolution was an extraordinarily popular first-season stallion in 2018. He has exemplarily credentials as a young stallion - he was extremely quick, very good looking and he's by a sire that's regularly breaking records and is achieving great things.

"Russian Revolution is an incredibly desirable young stallion, so the opportunity to be part of his story is a hugely appealing one, and we're very grateful to the China Horse Club to offer that lot."

Additional wildcard entries for The Chairman's Sale will be considered up to April 22.

High-class catalogue assembled for Australian Breeding and Broodmare Sale

One significant change from last year's format is that there will be no weanling session conducted during The Chairman's Sale, with the weanlings now incorporated into the Australian Breeding and Broodmare Sale, which will now take place either side of the elite sale.

Hutch said the feedback from vendors on *Continued on page 5>>*

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<< *Continued from page 4* the new format of the sale has been very positive and he is confident the revamp will suit the diverse buying bench Inglist hope to have assembled.

"The time looks to work well with the vendors and the feedback about the time has been very positive about the timing and the gap between this sale and the Easter Yearling Sale is something that they feel suits them better," he said.

"As a series, the breeding stock series is very important to us and we are trying to engage a very diverse group of people and to have a weanling sale prior to the start of The Chairman's gives us good momentum going into the mares sale."

There are some mouth-watering lots catalogued for the weanling arm of the Australian Breeding and Broodmare Sale, including the aforementioned weanlings by I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit) out of Group 1 winner Sirkani and Now Now's colt by Newgate Farm's exciting Slipper-winning sire Capitalist.

"We are very happy to way that book has come together - there are a number of highly-appealing lots in there," said Hutch.

"What is really positive thing about the weanling sale is that there are a number of offerings in the catalogue that will not only appeal to the pinhooking market, but also the end-user market," said Hutch.

"Particularly in New South Wales, the yearling sale market is very, very strong - so the weanling sale market offers an opportunity for people to get involved in quality stock at a less-competitive level.

"But the higher-end weanlings are sure to be sought after not just by the pinhookers, but by people as an opportunity to secure racehorses, and that's an exciting position to be in."

As part of the broodmare section of the catalogue there are mares in foal to the likes of I Am Invincible, Sebring (More Than Ready), Lonhro (Octagonal), So You Think (High Chaparral), Dundee (High Chaparral), Brazen Beau (I Am Invincible), Deep Field (Northern Meteor), Nicconi (Bianconi), Capitalist (Written Tycoon), Better Than Ready (More Than Ready) and Rubick (Encosta De Lago).

It will also be the first time for buyers to get their hands on the progeny of the first crop of the exciting first-season sires like Russian Revolution, Merchant Navy (Fastnet Rock), Hellbent (I Am Invincible), Invader (Snitzel), Caravaggio (Scat Daddy), Churchill (Galileo), Ribchester (Iffraaj), Pariah (Redoute's Choice), Impending (Lonhro), Highland Reel (Galileo), Jukebox (Snitzel), Menari (Snitzel), Spieth (Thorn Park) and Tosen Stardom (Deep Impact).

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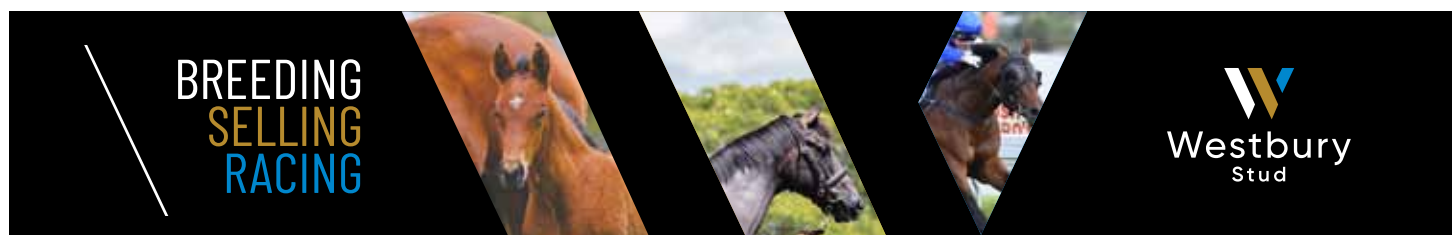

'Dream' result for Fletcher

Telemon Thoroughbreds owner Dan Fletcher cut a delighted figure in the aftermath of Kiamichi's (Sidestep) Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) victory on Saturday, hailing the win as a 'dream' result for first-season sire Sidestep (Exceed And Excel), who stands at Telemon following a two-year partnership agreement with Darley. "It's what dreams are made of and it was a dream result for Sidestep," he said. "He was runner-up in the Golden Slipper in 2013 and now his daughter has gone one better, but what it means for his stud career is exciting." Sidestep covered covered 57 mares at a fee of \$7,700 (inc GST) in Australia last year - his first season standing at Telemon Thoroughbreds having previously shuttled for Darley.

Three for Sidestep

Less than twenty-four hours on from Kiamichi's win, Longbottom (2 f ex Orphrey by Orpen) became the third individual winner for the son of Exceed And Excel (Danehill) when landing the Starmaker 2YO Handicap (1000m) at Muswellbrook yesterday. Trained by Brett Cavanough, the juvenile powered two and a half lengths clear of Brazen Gem (Brazen Beau) on debut, with a further half a length back to Salina Dreaming (Dream Ahead) in third.

First for He's A Decoy

He's A Decoy (In The Wings) was provided with his first stakes winner when He's A Parker (4 g ex Roman Gem by Bletchley Park) landed the Bull & Bush Tavern Cup (Listed, 2219m) at Bunbury yesterday. Trained by Hec McLaren, the four-year-old finished three-quarters of a length too strong for Come Play With Me (Blackfriars), with a further two and a half lengths back to Prying Tom (Black Tom) in third. He's A Decoy covered 15 mares at a private fee last year.

Paddock likely for The Autumn Sun

Rosehill Guineas (Gr 1, 2000m) winner The Autumn Sun (Redoute's Choice) is most likely destined for a spell, while co-owner John Messara has hinted the three-time Guineas hero could be retired following his fifth top-flight victory on Saturday. "Chris (Waller) said he pulled up well but he has had two gut busters now so I'm expecting a call to give him a spell," Messara told Sky Sports Radio. "He's had three runs this prep, two Group 1s and a Group 2 and he's won them all but they have been tough runs. The other part-owner lives in Hong Kong and have to get together over the next couple of weeks to talk about things. We've got 40 mares we are sending to him. There is a lot of interest in him and he doesn't have to do anything more."

Bowman booked on Stars Of Carrum in Derby

Hugh Bowman will get the leg up on Starts Of Carrum (Fiorente) for the first time in the Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) at Randwick on April 6 after trainer Robbie Laing confirmed the jockey has been booked for Saturday's Mornington Cup (Listed, 2400m) fourth. "He's run home his last 200 metres in 11.5 seconds and his last 50 metres was his strongest," Laing said of the three-year-old's weekend exploits. "I'm the happiest I've been with him for the whole preparation and I'm looking forward to the Derby. They (Bowman and his manager) thought looking at his runs he was a horse on the way up while some of the others might have already hit their peaks."

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Tancred for Avilius

James Cummings continues to ponder the idea of a quick return to the track for Ranvet Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) winner Avilius (Pivotal), with the trainer eyeing a tilt in the HE Tancred Stakes (Gr 1, 2400m) at Rosehill on Saturday for the gelding. "History is against him backing as a winner of the Ranvet in to the Tancred," Cummings said on RSN927 on Sunday morning. "Ultimately, I'm aware there will be no Winx next preparation, so it is very tempting to put that horse in the paddock and worry about races she would have otherwise been targeting. Alternatively, I expect he would start favourite in the Tancred next week and if he is right and he is going to be in the paddock next Monday anyway, there could be a strong argument mounted that the horse could take his place there and it would do him no harm."

Three for Newnham in Vinery

Mark Newnham is set to launch a three-pronged assault on the Vinery Stud Stakes (registered as the Storm Queen Stakes) (Gr 1, 2000m) after he confirmed Surround Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) winner Nakeeta Jane (So You Think) will be joined by Greysful Glamour (Stratum) and Scarlet Dream (Sebring). Nakeeta Jane will be partnered by regular rider Josh Parr, while Tim Clark is set to ride Greysful Glamour and Blake Shinn Scarlet Dream. All three fillies are due to gallop this morning in preparation for the \$500,000 prize.

Adrian Knox plan for Princess Jenni

David Brideoake has earmarked the Adrian Knox Stakes (Gr 3, 2000m) at Randwick on April 6 as the next stop for Friday evening's Alexandra Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m) winner Princess Jenni (High Chaparral). The three-year-old was winning for the first time in Group company when getting up close home under Damien Oliver and she could be in for a quick back-up, with the ATC Oaks (registered as the ATC Australian Oaks) (Gr 1, 2400m) also a possibility at the same course the following week. "I will make a judgment call whether she is still too brilliant to run in the Oaks depending on how we go over the 2000 metres," Brideoake said. "If she arrives up in Sydney in good shape

you would have to think she'd be a force to be reckoned with. That long, sustained run impressed me and Damien has been in touch and will ride her in Sydney."

Plans up in the air for Dixie Blossoms

Ron Quinton will make a decision early this week if Coolmore Classic (registered as the TAD Kennedy Stakes) (Gr 1, 1500m) winner Dixie Blossoms (Street Sense) will run in the Emancipation Stakes (Gr 2, 1500m) at Rosehill on Saturday or wait and week and line-up in the Doncaster Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) on the opening day of The Championships at Randwick. The six-year-old was making her breakthrough in Group 1 company when powering two and a half lengths clear of El Dorado Dreaming (Ilovethiscity), while she finished a half-length third behind Prompt Response (Beneteau) in the Emancipation Stakes last year.

Queen Elizabeth for Danzdanzzdance

A clash with Winx (Street Cry) in the Queen Elizabeth Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) at Randwick on April 13 beckons for dual Group 1 winner Danzdanzzdance (Mastercraftman) following the four-year-old's fine third in the Ranvet Stakes at the weekend. "It was a superb effort," co-trainer Michelle Bradley said. "Opie (Bosson) said that there was no-one really going for the lead and she started travelling and getting up on the bit. She's a horse that does need cover, as once she gets it, she settles. If he'd just let her go a little bit forward and got one spot handier (she might have got closer at the finish), but we're stoked with that run, just really happy."

He's Eminent Randwick-bound

The likely line-up for Winx's farewell contest has

been given further shape after Sir Mark Todd confirmed He's Eminent (Frankel) will also line-up in the Queen Elizabeth. The European import was a three-time winner for Martyn Meade, including the Prix Guillaume d'Ornano (Gr 2, 2000m) at Deauville, and he made a promising introduction to the southern hemisphere when filling the runner-up spot behind Avilius in the Ranvet Stakes on Saturday. "I was thrilled with his run," Todd said. "For a horse who has never run on ground like that and not having run since August last year, that was always going to be our weak link. He's run a huge race and pulled up very well, so we just have to hope for good ground next time. We will see how he comes through this, but I think it will really bring him on, with the Queen Elizabeth being our main target all along."

First Crush heading to Toowoomba Cup

Chris Munce will send First Crush (Husson) straight to the Toowoomba Cup (2150m) on April 6 after deciding against running the seven-year-old at Doomben on Saturday. "He is a clean-winded horse and he seems to race well with his races spaced," Munce said. "Hopefully, he can race well and then we can look at the better races this winter." First Crush has won seven of his 39 starts, including the Grafton Cup (Listed, 2350m) in July, while he was last seen running second in the Members' Cup (Listed, 1615m) at Brisbane on March 2.

Nature Strip owner not convinced on Royal Ascot plan

Co-owner Rod Lyons is not yet sold on the idea of a trip to Royal Ascot with Saturday's The Galaxy (Gr 1, 1100m) winner Nature Strip (Nicconi), with Chris Waller having mooted a tilt at the King's Stand Stakes (Gr 1, 5f) for the four-year-old. "I'm not too bothered about racing in front of the Queen and I'm not sure if it is the best decision for the horse either," Lyons told Racing.com. "It could be a bit of fun to travel and have a holiday but the racing over there isn't worth that much and he is a gelding. We may still go, I'm not sure at this point, but you've got to weigh up what cost it potentially has on the horse long term and what you could sacrifice by staying here."

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Tumbler retired

A hairline fracture in a leg has forced Barry Lockwood to call time on the career of leading Brisbane mare Tumbler (Time Thief), who won eight of her 18 starts despite suffering an injury-plagued career. "She is seven-years-old and really it is time to retire her," he said. "She will go through the Magic Millions National Sale in June. She will make a lovely broodmare. I am just sorry we never got to see the very best of her on the racetrack." Tumbler amassed \$292,475 in prize-money having also hit the frame on a further six occasions, including when running second in the WJ Healy Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) at Eagle Farm last June.

Pascoe made a BRC life member

Noel Pascoe, one of Australia's best known racing photographers, has been made a life member of the Brisbane Racing Club. In a ceremony at Eagle Farm on Saturday, Pascoe was given his life membership to recognise his 72 years of service in Brisbane racing. "Noel was only eight years old when he started work taking photographs at the start of races at Eagle Farm, Doomben and Albion Park," BRC chairman Neville Bell said. "He still works every Saturday at the races for Racing Queensland and is always available to help all clubs." Pascoe said it was an honour to be given the life membership and he has enjoyed every minute of his working life. "I reckon it is nearly 30 years since I missed a race meeting in Brisbane on a Saturday," he said.

Tasmanian trainer Mick Burles dies

Mick Burles, who gained national fame as the trainer of cult horse The Cleaner (Savoire Vivre), has died in Tasmania following a long battle with emphysema, the Australian Trainers Association has confirmed. Burles, who retired due to ill-health last year, started training in 1976, but he shot to prominence in more recent times through the exploits of perennial front-runner The Cleaner, who became the first Tasmanian-trained horse to run in a Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) when finishing ninth in 2014. The Cleaner, who was transferred to Peter Gelagotis for his final four races, was retired in 2016

having won 19 of his 58 starts, including the Dato' Tan Chin Nam Stakes (registered as the John F Feehan Stakes) (Gr 2, 1600m) in 2015, amassing prize-money of \$1,349,771.

Williams moves to Ballarat

Amy McDonald has announced she is relocating her training operation to Ballarat, taking control of a 15-box stable. "We were drawn to Ballarat for the first-class training and racing facilities which will be a huge asset for Amy McDonald Racing," McDonald said. "We're also a family-focused business so were enticed by the benefits of moving our operations to a community where we can put down a strong foundation for our family."

New Zealand

Stakes races the plan for Artiste

The Manawatu Breeders' (Gr 3, 2000m) at Awapuni on April 5 is the likely target for Artiste (Mastercraftsman) following her success in the Bay Of Plenty Cup (2100m) at Tauranga on Saturday. Ridden by apprentice Taiki Yanagida, the five-year-old was winning for the sixth time in her career, and the fourth this preparation, while she will now step into stakes company for the first time in her 28-race career. "That was a really gutsy win that was set up by a perfect ride," co-trainer Andrew Forsman said. "I thought he (Yanagida) put her in a great spot throughout and she really benefited from his claim, as she got a good pull in the weights from her main rivals. She has really strengthened up during this campaign and is reaping the benefits of that now. I would think a tilt at some black-type is the obvious choice and the race at Awapuni sets up nicely as it's against her own sex over a good distance for her."

Robinson mulls options for Boots 'N' All

Boots 'N' All (Perfectly) completed a treble for Lance Robinson when landing the Seaton Family Memorial Hororata Gold Cup (1800m) in the hands of apprentice Corey Campbell at Riccarton on Saturday and the six-year-old is set to return to Group company for his next start. "He (Boots 'N' All) is just a little fella and he has been struggling a bit with the big weights," Robinson said. "The two-kilogram claim made a

big difference to him and once again he showed just how tough he is. I had been thinking about the Awapuni Gold Cup but it would be his fourth trip north in this prep which might be a little too much for him. I think the Canterbury Gold Cup (run at Riccarton on April 13) next month might be a better option for him."

27 for Scat Daddy

Late Coolmore resident Scat Daddy (Johannesburg) was provided with his 27th Grade / Group 1 winner when Mr Melody (4 c ex Trusty Lady by Deputy Minister) landed the Takamatsunomiya Kinen (Gr 1, 1200m) at Chukyo yesterday. Seiun Kosei (Admire Moon) finished half a length down in second, while Shonan Anthem (Jungle Pocket) was a further head away in third. Scat Daddy died at Coolmore's Ashford Stud in Kentucky in 2015, although his legacy was cemented on the track through the exploits of Triple Crown winner Justify last year, while his sire-son shuttler No Nay Never made an explosive impact with his first European two-year-old runners in 2018, including siring a top-flight winner in the form of Ten Sovereigns. 30 for Symboli Kris S

Satono Titan (6 h ex Machikanekichikoyore by Deputy Minister) became the 30th stakes for Breeders Stallion Station resident Symboli Kris S (Kris S) when winning the March Stakes (Gr 3, 1800m) at Nakayama yesterday. London Town (Kane Hekili) finished a length and a quarter away in second, while Regent Rock (Daiwa Major) was a further neck back in third. Symboli Kris S has sired five Group 1 winners including Epiphaneia, who won the Japan Cup in 2014.



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Viddora in top order for Dubai assignment

The Lloyd Kennewell-trained Viddora (I Am Invincible) will gallop on the course-proper at Meydan on Tuesday as she prepares for Saturday's Al Quoz Sprint (Gr 1, 1200m) and regular rider Joe Bowditch, who guided the six-year-old to victories in the Winterbottom Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) in 2017 and the A.J. Moir Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) last year, has issued a positive bulletin on his mount. "We were lucky enough to gallop her up the straight at Flemington with a mate before she left and she worked quite well," he said. "That being her second time up the straight, she seemed to handle it all right and hit the line really well but it'll be nice to have a look at the straight there though. From all reports she's settled in really well, she's eating up and we couldn't have her in better nick going into the race."

International

59 for Mastercraftsman

Progressive four-year-old Still Standing (4 c ex - Il Palazzo by Giant's Causeway) made the perfect seasonal return when becoming the 59th stakes winner for Coolmore Stud resident Mastercraftsman (Danehill Dancer) in the Devoy Stakes (Listed, 10f) at Naas yesterday. Trained by Jessica Harrington, Still Standing won three of his four starts in handicap company last year and he took this step up in class in his stride when powering three and a half lengths clear of Hazel Bay (Ifraaj), while there was a further length and a half back to Amedeo Modigliani (Galileo) in third. Still Standing is from the family of dual US Grade 1 winner Senure (Nureyev), who subsequently stood in India, while Mastercraftsman is currently standing for a fee of €30,000.

Normandel's First Group win

Jim Bolger made his customary bright start to the Irish Flat season when saddling a treble at Naas yesterday and his three winners included a maiden Group-race success for Normandel (5 m Le Havre - Lidana by King's Best) in the Express Stakes (Gr 3, 1m). half-length back to Yulong Gold Fairy (Mount Nelson) in third. Bred By Franklin Finance, Normandel is by Montfort et Preaux resident Le Havre (Noverre), while she is from the family of dual Group 1 Linngari (Indian Ridge), who was placed behind the Bolger-trained New Approach (Galileo) in the 2008 renewal of the Champion Stakes (Gr 1, 10f) when the race was then run at Newmarket.

Presley returns a winner

Presley (6 h Gladiatorus - Pasionaria by Celtic Swing) made a successful seasonal reappearance when winning the Premio Circo Massimo (Listed, 2000m) at Milan yesterday. Now a 13-time winner, the six-year-old secured a first stakes success in the Premio Regione Toscana (Listed, 2200m) at Pisa on his return last March and he repeated the dose with a half-length victory over Azzurro Cobalto (Aussie Rules), with a further three-quarters of a length back to Time To Choose (Manduro) in third. Gladiatorus (Silic) stood for seven seasons at Allevamento di Besnate in Italy prior to transferring to Withslade Farm in Britain for 2018. Presley is a half-brother to six winners, including Italian Derby (Gr 1, 2200m) third Papetti (Shantou).

Fourth stakes win for Wait

Wait Forever (4 h Camelot - Mount McLeod by Holy Roman Emperor) secured his fourth win at stakes level with a victory over Poet Diletto (Poet's Voice) in the Premio Natale Di Roma (Listed, 1600m) in Milan yesterday. Purchased by his trainer Alduino Botti from Pier House Stud for €22,000 at the Tattersalls Ireland September Yearling Sale, Wait Forever is one of 13 stakes winners for Coolmore Stud sire Camelot (Montjeu), who is standing at the Tipperary-based stud for a fee of €40,000.

Four for Goldcents

By My Standards (3 c ex A Jealous Woman by Muqtarib) became the fourth stakes winner for Spendthrift Farm resident Goldcents (Into Mischief) when he landed the Louisiana Derby (Gr 2, 9f) at Fair Grounds on Saturday. Spinoff (Hard Spun) finished three-quarters of a length back in second, while there were five lengths back to Sueno (Atreides) in third. Goldcents is currently standing for a fee of US\$20,000 and Be My Standards joins Silvercents, Always

Hope and Pickett as stakes winners for the son of Into Mischief (Harlan's Holiday), who was three-time Group 1, winner including back-to-back renewals of the Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile (Gr 1, 1m) at Santa Anita in 2013 and 2014.

Right Choice digs deep for De Sousa in Sha Tin feature

Right Choice (Mastercraftsman) edged an enthralling duel for the Kowloon Cricket Club Centenary Cup Handicap (1600m) at Sha Tin on Sunday to sweeten what jockey Silvestre de Sousa felt was a wrong decision one race prior.

The Brazilian was all but forced to lead the Class 2 feature race on the talented four-year-old - a move that almost backfired.

"The way the race was run wasn't suitable for him," De Sousa said. "It was such a slow pace and with the weight he carried I felt the best position would be where he was in front, so he'd be in the right place at the right time, but he was never happy to be there doing the work.

Fellow Brazilian Joao Moreira pressured the leader aboard top-weight Time To Celebrate (Per Incanto), never allowing De Sousa's mount to relax, and when De Sousa had to ask questions of Right Choice entering the home straight, Moreira was there to pounce.

Time To Celebrate edged the lead with 400 metres to race and looked momentarily as though he had the \$1.9 favourite's measure. However, De Sousa was in no mood for capitulation and a powerful drive galvanized Right Choice, with the New Zealand-bred

rallying to regain the lead at the 200-metre mark before holding on as the brave Time To Celebrate lunged again at the line.

"He dug deep!" De Sousa said. "I'd like to ride him again over a mile but be more patient and let him come home from the back.

"He felt like he was still immature and babyish. He just wants to be in a fast pace where he can come home strongly. I hope he's better than he showed today."

The Frankie Lor-trained gelding scored by a nose in 1m 35.25s to take his career tally to five wins from six starts.

"He couldn't find any horse to lead so he got lost in front," Lor said. "He learned something and next time, if nothing leads and he finds he's in front, he will be better.

"I'll look at the programme and see if we stay at a mile or go back to 1400 (metres) and maybe give him a month off."

De Sousa wrapped up his four-month winter contract in Hong Kong with 44 wins - an impressive haul - thanks to the Mastercraftsman gelding's effort, but Britain's three-time champion jockey could not conceal his chagrin at the demotion of Utopia Life (Wicked Style) in the Class 3 Hillwood Handicap (1000m).

The Manfred Man-trained three-year-old passed the post ahead of the rest but shifted out under the Brazilian's drive, consequently closing a gap and impeding the fast-finishing Seven Heavens (Frankel), who snatched up dramatically under Martin Harley before crossing the line in fourth.

The Stewards called an inquiry and an objection was lodged for good measure. Utopia Life was placed fourth, with runner-up Multimillion (Tycoon Ruler) promoted to first place and the Caspar Fownes-trained Seven Heavens upped one position to third.

"I thought the Stewards took the wrong decision to disqualify me but they make the decisions," De Sousa said.

Voyage cruises

Voyage Warrior's (Declaration Of War) win in the Class 4 Pine Tree Hill Handicap (1000m) was widely-anticipated but that did not diminish the palpable "wow" and the manner of the debutant's four-length triumph was all that his connections had hoped for - perhaps a little more.

Jockey Karis Teetan - the beneficiary of De Sousa's demotion as the rider of Multimillion - found the lead easily from the rail-side gate 14 and the inexperienced Declaration Of War gelding relished the trail-blazing role.

By the 500-metre point he had burnt off the harrying Great Fit; by the furlong pole he was clear and cruising towards what could have been a dozen-length margin; at the 100 metre, ears pricked as his supporters celebrated, the chestnut was eased down, his work done, the victory sealed.

"The horse showed a great turn-of-foot and he's done nothing wrong so far. He's a very exciting horse to progress," trainer Ricky Yiu said after his charge had stopped the clock at 56.65s, with a final 400 metre split of 22.67s.

"They'll give him a double-digit rise in rating so he'll go into Class 3 now but if I keep running him over the thousand (metres) he will win a couple more, at least. He just needs to learn to settle - that will make him a better horse," Yiu said.

"He's still green, he's still learning. He was running around a little bit towards the last furlong and the jockey got a little bit excited and dropped his stick - but he didn't need it anyway!"

The three-year-old debutant returned the \$1.5 favourite on the back of two blitzing barrier trials in recent weeks. Those warm-up efforts gave Teetan confidence going into the Australian-bred galloper's first assignment.

"He's a nice little horse and we expected him to run well," the Mauritian ace said.

"He's been trialling a similar way so it wasn't too surprising, and it wasn't the strongest field today, but it's good that he won and he still doesn't know much about what is happening around him or what he should do. I think there is still a long way to go with him and a few things to fix but it was a good first step."

Purton bags three

Champion jockey Zac Purton bagged a treble to take his season's tally to 89, 26 clear of next-best Teetan.

Purton teamed with the Man-trained Natural Flame (Ishiguru) to take the 1200 metre Class 5; guided second-time starter Band Of Brothers (Sakhee's Secret) from deep to land

the Class 4 Jordan Handicap (1400m) for trainer Paul O'Sullivan; and enjoyed the perfect sit in third before cruising down the dirt track's home straight for a length-and-three-quarters win on the Dennis Yip-trained Chung Wah Spirit (Dash For Cash).

Richard Gibson made history when saddling the first ever winner at Conghua Racecourse yesterday (Saturday, 23 March) and the trainer followed up with victory in this afternoon's Sha Tin opener.

Grant van Niekerk nailed his first win atop a Gibson galloper – at his second ride for the stable – when Ruminare (Fastnet Rock) broke his maiden at the 19th attempt in the Class 5 Tak Shing Handicap (1400m).

Jack Wong endured a barren spell that stretched from November 11 to March 2 but the rider was on the mark for the second time this month when Flying Lover (Sepoy) landed the 1200 metre Class 4 on the dirt track. Me Tsui's galloper surged over the top of his rivals to land a first win at start 20.

Umberto Rispoli now has 16 wins for the season after guiding the David Ferraris-trained Honest Way (Per Incanto) to success in race eight. Joao Moreira got on the day's scoresheet in the finale, nicking the spoils on top-weight Beauty Spirit (Duporth) to give the Tony Cruz stable a double.

Hong Kong racing continues at Happy Valley on Wednesday.


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Drop-back style suits Golden Years

Quieter riding tactics bore instant dividends for consistent three-year-old Golden Years (Jimmy Choux) in the \$75,000 Restricted Maiden race over 1200m on Sunday.

Held up close to the pace at four of his past five runs at Kranji, the gelding still performed very well, never finishing out of the money.

But trainer Michael Clements and jockey Vlad Duric decided they would take a leaf from the only time he took a sit at the rear, not that it was really by design. From a wide draw in a similar Restricted Maiden 1200 metre event in November, jockey Olivier Placais had no other choice but to snag him back at the tail of the field before they came motoring home for second place.

From another awkward alley (nine) drawn in Sunday's race, Golden Years was switched off into a midfield spot and saved for that last charge to the post.

It was clear the new battle plan would come off at the top of the straight. As newcomer and race-leader Mr Alfonso (Highly Recommended) came back to the field at the 300 metres, the race was all done and dusted when Golden Years was revved-up by Duric.

Attacking the line down the middle, Golden Years accelerated beautifully to go and gap his rivals by just under four lengths. Another debutant (there were nine in the 12-horse field) St Alwyn (Epauvette) reproduced the promise shown at his barrier trials with a worthy second place first-up with Lim's Craft (Smart Missile)

a fast-closing third another neck away. The winning time was 1:9.65 for the 1200 metres on the Short Course.

"It was a great run from the horse and it's paid off. He came up with another good effort two runs back when he got back in the field and finished strongly," said Clements.

"He was gelded shortly after and has come back stronger. I think he can go up to Class 4; he clocked a bit of time today.

"We've been half-thinking about the Three-Year-Old Sprint in a couple of weeks. From the way he ran today, it's possible, but we'll have to see if he has enough ratings to get in."

The Singapore Three-Year-Old Challenge kicks off with the Singapore Three-Year-Old Sprint (Listed, 1200m) on April 5, then proceeds to the Singapore Three-Year-Old Classic (Listed, 1400m) on May 3, before wrapping up with the Singapore Guineas (Listed, 1600m) on May 25.

Duric said Golden Years was able to showcase his true potential thanks to the change in tactics.

"He's a different horse when he is ridden quiet," said the two-time Singapore champion jockey who, after a relatively subdued start, is starting to draw clear in the current premiership on 25 winners, eight clear of Noh Senari.

"I had him one off the fence and once I pulled him out, he was very dominant. I think he can get over more ground, too.

"I'm not sure about the 3YO series as I think Mike has better three-year-olds, but I can be a bad judge at times!"

Even though Golden Years was shedding his maiden status, his previous smart record of five placings from as many starts explains why his stakes earnings have already hit the SGP\$100,000 mark for the Falcon Racing No 7 Stable.
