

American Triple Crown winner Justify to shuttle to Coolmore

Son of Scat Daddy an exciting addition to the stud's New South Wales roster

he Australian stallion ranks will receive a significant boost this year, with the undefeated American Triple Crown winner Justify (Scat Daddy) set to shuttle to Coolmore Stud in New South Wales.

Justify, who was unbeaten in all six starts, earning US\$3,798,000 in the process, will stand for a private fee alongside 2015 Triple Crown winner American Pharoah (Pioneerof The Nile) and fellow Group 1-winning son of Scat Daddy (Johannesburg) Carravaggio at the operation's base in Jerrys Plains.

One of 27 individual Group 1 winners for Coolmore's late stallion Scat Daddy, Justify is currently covering his first book of mares at Coolmore's Ashford Stud for a fee of US\$150,000.

"Justify was a phenomenal racehorse who re-wrote the history books through his achievements on the track. It is an absolute privilege to stand him at Coolmore Australia alongside our other Triple Crown winner American Pharoah, who has already been so well supported by Australasian breeders" said Coolmore Australia principal, Tom Magnier.



High-class mares catalogued for Magic Millions National Broodmare Sale

A high-class band of mares have been catalogued for the Magic Millions National Broodmare Sale on the Gold Coast on May 28, which is headed by dual Group 1 winner Global Glamour (Star Witness), who will be offered in foal to Widden Stud stallion Zoustar (Northern Meteor).

Global Glamour was confirmed as an entry for the Queensland sale by her connections last month and yesterday the auction house released a small sample of entries they have received for the sale, with the full catalogue due to be released in the coming weeks.

"This is a small sample of what our catalogue will provide this year," Barry Bowditch, Magic Millions managing director, told ANZ Bloodstock News yesterday. "Not only have the vendors given us a huge lot of mares, but they have given us a heap of quality as well, which we are grateful for.

"It sets us up nicely to attract a huge international and domestic market to the sale in late May.

«Continued from page 1 Scat Daddy, meanwhile, is already beginning to make a name for himself as a sire of sires. His exploits as a grandsire have been well advertised this year by his son No Nay Never, whose first crop of runners in Europe yielded 38 winners, with Group 1 winner Ten Sovereigns among his seven stakes winners.

"Scat Daddy was an incredible sire who has made an instant impact as a sire of sires and we look forward to standing his best son in Jerrys Plains," Magnier continued.

Bred by John Gunther, Justify was purchased by China Horse

Club and Maverick Racing for US\$500,000 at the Keeneland September Yearling Sale and was sent into training with Bob Baffert, who had also trained American Pharoah to win the coveted American Triple Crown three years beforehand.

The colt was raced by China Horse Club, Head of Plains Partners LLC, Starlight Racing and WinStar Farm during his racing career.

Justify was not seen on a : racetrack as a two-year-old, but :

stamped himself as a major contender for the Classics when breaking his maiden on debut over seven furlongs at Santa Anita in emphatic style - beating Camby (Candy Ride) by a remarkable nine and a half lengths.

He was then stepped up to a mile on his next start, which he won equally impressively, defeating Shivermetimbers (Shanghai Bobby) by six and a half lengths.

On his next start Justify

won the first of his four consecutive Grade 1 victories, easily beating dual Grade 1 winner Bolt D'Oro (Medaglia d'Oro) by three lengths and earning himself a start in the Kentucky Derby (Gr 1, 10f), where he defeated subsequent Group 1 winner Good Magic (Curlin) and Florida Derby (Gr 1, 9f) winner Audible (Into Mischief), who finished second and third respectively.

Arguably the colt's toughest win came in the Preakness Stakes (Gr 1, 9.5f), where he showed immense courage to perform in the wet conditions and beat Bravazo (Awesome Again) by half a length. *Continued on page 4>>*

Continued from page 2 The colt's final start came in the Belmont Stakes (Gr 1, 12f) where he led from pillar to post, eventually beating subsequent Dubai World Cup (Gr 1, 2000m) runner-up Gronkowski (Lonhro) by a decisive length and three quarters, etching himself among the greats of horse racing as only the 13th American Triple Crown winner in history - for which he was later named US Horse of the Year.

Coolmore Stud bought into the colt following his Triple Crown success in September 2018.

Justify hails from the penultimate crop of Scat Daddy (Johannesburg), who died suddenly at Coolmore's Ashford Stud in Kentucky in 2015 aged 11, just as he had established himself as one of the greatest sires in the world.

Justify is out of Stage Magic, a Grade 3-placed daughter of another outstanding colt in Ghostzapper (Awesome Again), making him a half-brother to Grade 3 winner The Lieutenant (Street Sense). Stage Magic is

in turn out of the Grade 1-placed mare Magical Illusion, who is by the influential Pulpit (A.P. Indy) out of Grade 3 winner Voodoo Lily (Baldski).

"History tells us; the best racehorses make the best sires. Justify is a horse of incredibly rare ability, and to stand him alongside fellow US Triple



Crown winner American Pharoah in the Hunter Valley is a huge show of faith in the strength of the Australian industry by the Magnier family" said Coolmore Australia's sales and nominations manager, Colm Santry.

"There have been two US Triple Crown winners in the last 40 years and he is the 13th in history. They will both stand alongside our very own Australian Triple Crown winning two-year-old Pierro, who has already proven himself as one of the best sires in the country.

"It's probably the first time in history that three Triple Crown winners have stood at one stud in the same season anywhere in the world. It is hugely exciting and we are very much looking forward to showing Justify to Australasian breeders in a couple of months' time."

Brave Smash retired to take up stud duties at Aquis

Dual Group 1 winner Brave Smash (Tosen Phantom) has been retired to stud and will stand at Aquis Farm in the Hunter Valley for a fee of \$20,000 (plus GST) in 2019. Winner of the Futurity Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) and the Manikato Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) during a stellar career on track, in which his five wins helped yield a prize-money haul of \$3,602,686, Brave Smash ran third in the Newmarket Handicap (Gr 1, 1200m) on his final Australian start before rounding off his career with a creditable eighth in the Al Quoz Sprint (Gr 1, 1200m) at Meydan last Saturday. He will stand alongside the likes

of Invader (Snitzel), Jukebox (Snitzel), Spieth (Thorn Park) and Divine Prophet (Choisir) at Aquis's NSW base.

Smart Missile fee

Meanwhile, Twin Hills Stud stallion Smart Missile (Fastnet Rock) has had his fee set at \$22,000 (inc GST) for the 2019 breeding season. The increase sees him return to the figure he stood at for his first six seasons at stud, having been available for a reduced fee of \$13,200 in 2018. Smart Missile is the sire of 10 stakes winners, spearheaded by Spring Champion Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) winner Maid Of Heaven, and is currently fifth on the leading sires by winners standings, placing him behind I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit), Snitzel

(Redoute's Choice), Written Tycoon (Iglesia) and the late Sebring (More Than Ready).

Sunlight in peak condition ahead of 'toughest test'

Triple Group 1 winner Sunlight (Zoustar) is reportedly in fine fettle ahead of her outing in the TJ Smith Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) at Randwick on Saturday. Regular rider Luke Currie partnered the Tony McEvoy-trained mare in her final gallop on Randwick's course proper on Tuesday and is confident she will be right in the finish. "It's a really good field on Saturday so she probably has to step up but not that much to be a winning chance," Currie told Racing. com. "She worked really well (at Randwick on Tuesday morning), she always works well."



Snowden backing Redzel to bounce back

Co-trainer Paul Snowden has no doubt that Redzel (Snitzel) can bounce back from an uncharacteristic last-start flop when he takes on a high-class field in the TJ Smith Stakes at Randwick tomorrow. The dual Everest (1200m) winner finished down the track in The Galaxy (Gr 1, 1100m) at Rosehill two weeks ago but connections feel he had genuine excuses for the below-par performance. "We've just got to put a line through it. He got a severe check at a vital stage which didn't aid his chances one little bit," Snowden said. "It happened right at a stage when he's usually towing into the race and with the weight he had to give everything, he was under the pump and yielding ground and that just doesn't happen with this horse."

Litt confident Castelvecchio can cause upset at Randwick

Having bypassed the Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m), Richard Litt is confident stable star Castelvecchio (Dundeel) can put

his freshness to good use and upset the market principals in tomorrow's Inglis Sires' (registered as ATC Sires' Produce Stakes) (Gr 1, 1400m) at Randwick. "Those horses backing up from the Slipper, obviously they've done well enough to run, but you never know if it will take a toll on them," Litt said. "So that's the plan. To come in nice and fresh and happy, ready to rock, and see how good we are. I see the horse every day and I'm pretty stoked with him."

Coolmore Legacy for Nakeeta Jane

Surround Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) winner Nakeeta Jane (So You Think) will bypass the Australian Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) and will instead drop back in distance for another Group 1 contest on the second day of The Championships at Randwick. Trainer Mark Newnham has advised Racing NSW stewards to remove the filly from nominations for Saturday week's Oaks, with Nakeeta Jane set to run in the Coolmore Legacy Stakes (registered as Queen Of The

Turf Stakes) (Gr 1, 1600m) on the same card. The filly finished fourth in last Saturday's Vinery Stud Stakes (registered as Storm Queen Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) won by Oaks favourite Verry Elleegant (Zed).

Global Exchange out to hit new heights at Randwick

Ciaron Maher is hoping to see a long term plan come to fruition at Randwick tomorrow when the progressive Global Exchange (Dundeel) takes his chance in the Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2400m). The colt comes into the race off the back of an unbeaten three-run campaign in Victoria, including victories in the Autumn Classic (Gr 2, 1800m) and Alister Clark Stakes (Gr 2, 2040m). "It has been a targeted plan. He's in great order," Maher, who trains in partnership with David Eustace, said. "I think he will really appreciate the mile-and-a-half and he's got a sense of timing about him. Kerrin McEvoy said he was no problem going the other way in the trial and he had a nice gallop on Tuesday. He should be pretty right to go."



Bowman banking on Hartnell in Doncaster

Hugh Bowman is hopeful of snaring a second Doncaster Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) victory at Randwick on Saturday when he partners Hartnell (Authorized) on what will be the gelding's 50th start. The Godolphin-raced veteran will be bidding to join Happy Clapper (Teofilo), Winx (Street Cry) and Super Impose (Imposing) as the only horses in the past 40 years to claim the Epsom Handicap (Gr 1, 1600m)-Doncaster Mile double in the same season. "We won the Epsom together and he's just so consistent," Bowman

said. "His run in the All-Star Mile was excellent, you could say he might have been unlucky not to win that and I love the draw for him."

McNeil hoping to star in Doncaster Mile

Elsewhere in tomorrow's Doncaster Mile, Jye McNeil will be gunning for that elusive first Group 1 win when he partners Fifty Stars (Sea The Stars) in the \$3 million contest. The Lindsay Park-trained colt heads into the race having taken out the Blamey Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m) and Ajax Stakes (Gr 2, 1500m) at his past two starts. "He was terrific through the line the other day and I think that Randwick, at this stage, is not going to be as wet as what it was at Rosehill," McNeil said. "He can let go with a terrific turn of foot, so with no weight (50 kilograms) it gives me a lot of confidence."

Frankely Awesome out of Derby

Kris Lees has scratched Frankely Awesome (Frankel) from tomorrow's Australian Derby on veterinary advice. Lees said the three-year-old

filly had been coughing and had subsequently not recovered well enough following her second placing in the Vinery Stud Stakes last Saturday. It is expected the daughter of Frankel (Galileo) will now race in the Australian Oaks at Randwick on April 13, with a veterinary clearance required before she can race again.

Weights raised for Sydney Cup

Racing NSW have used their discretion to oppose conventional handicapping procedures for Australian Group 1 races, with the weights for the \$2 million Sydney Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) set to be raised by potentially as little as 0.5 kilograms. British import Muntahaa (Muntahaa) currently heads the weights with 55.5 kilograms, meaning a rise of 0.5 will see him carry less than the 57 kilograms top-weight stipulated in the Australian Rule of Racing. "Having assessed the possible field and taking into consideration all relevant factors, the 2019 Group 1 Sydney Cup will be raised to a maximum top-weight of 56kg," the Racing NSW statement said.





Gallic Chieftain attempting to nab first win for Alexander

Archie Alexander is confident that Gallic Chieftain (Tamayuz) can secure a first win under his stewardship when the French import lines up in tomorrow's Chairman's Quality (Gr 2, 2600m) at Randwick. Formerly prepared by Darren Weir, Gallic Chieftain runs for the third time under Alexander's care having finished fifth on his two outings this preparation. "I don't think he's an outsider, he's around 13/1, but I think he's got a good solid chance," Alexander said. "He's won in Sydney. He's won

on the ground. Damian Lane's got form on him. Blinkers go back on. So he ticks a lot of boxes."

Forster's Weetwood hopes rely on Malvern Estate


Malvern Estate (Redoute's Choice) will bid to end a long run of outs when he tackles the Weetwood Handicap (Listed, 1200m) at Toowoomba tomorrow. The Desleigh Forstertrained gelding has failed to get his head in front since February last year and comes into the race having finished runner-up in the Goldmarket Handicap (Listed, 1200m) for the second year in succession. "If any horse deserves a win it is him. I think the Weetwood is the right race for him as there is always plenty of early pace," Forster said.

Divanation adds a second win to her CV

Divanation (All Too Hard), a daughter of threetime Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) heroine Makybe Diva (Desert King), recorded her second victory from four starts when scoring over 1750 metres at Geelong yesterday. The Tony McEvoytrained filly now has stakes company in her sights, with the Centaurea Stakes (Listed, 2000m) at Morphettville on May 18 mooted as a potential future target by McEvoy's Melbourne foreman Michael Shepherdson. "Tony's got good plans for her," Shepherdson said. "We've been real patient with her, taken our time and we're going to be rewarded."

Currie charged again

Hours after Ben Currie received another stay of proceedings on Wednesday, Queensland Racing Integrity Commission stewards laid two additional charges against the Toowoomba trainer. The latest two charges against Currie allege jigger usage, bringing the total number of charges he faces to 37. The Queensland Civil and Administrative Tribunal on Wednesday allowed for Currie's stay of proceedings hearing to be adjourned to allow his legal team to sift through affidavit material received from the QRIC on Tuesday. It is now likely the stay hearing will be heard from April 16-18.

Caulfield track condition 'not ideal'

Track manager Jason Kerr has expressed concern over the condition of Caulfield's racing surface following a five-week renovation. The renovation itself has reportedly had an 'adverse effect' on the inside 10 metres of the track, causing slight worry ahead of four weeks of consecutive racing at the Melbourne venue. "The track is in reasonable condition, we gave it a renovation after Blue Diamond Stakes Day," Kerr told Racing.com. "We've only had the five weeks coming off the back of the renovation

and usually it's eight or nine weeks. The track is a little bit new...it will race ok, but certainly another couple of weeks would have been ideal."

Finnegan sidelined

South Australian jockey Emily Finnegan looks set to be sidelined for up to six weeks after finding out she requires shoulder surgery. Finnegan fell at Morphettville last month when riding Embley (High Chaparral) for Will Clarken in the Matrice Stakes (Listed, 1200m) on March 11. Cleared of serious injury after the fall, Finnegan rode at Naracoorte two days later, where she had six rides, before partnering another three horses at Morphettville on March 16. A precautionary x-ray subsequently has shown a 4mm chip of the bone in her shoulder and a slight tear to her ligament.

Newitt cleared in betting probe

No action will be taken against Group 1-winning jockey Craig Newitt following the conclusion of a betting investigation. The 34-year-old confirmed to media outlets in February that a request had been made for him to front Racing Victoria stewards, though RV confirmed yesterday in a statement that no action would be taken under the Rules of Racing. "To be honest I wasn't too worried about it because I knew I'd done nothing wrong," Newitt told Racing.com. "Understandably the stewards had to go through their processes. I'm just looking to get on with it and have a big few months ahead."

Anderson set to leave Racing.com



ATC Foundation funds for drought relief

The Australian Turf Club (ATC) Foundation has started rolling out its drought relief funds for racing industry participants across several towns in the NSW Central and Western Districts. Thoroughbred trainers in Nyngan, Trangie, Narromine, Dubbo, Gligandra, Coonamble, Cobar and Cuttabri will receive bales of hay and the Walgett Jockey Club will receive funds for the provision of water in the worst affected areas. The ATC Foundation has raised more than \$60,000 in the first stage through the sale of merchandise on racecourses, saddle cloth auctions and a percentage of prize money won by the ATC's runner Osborne Bulls (Street Cry) in the 2018 Everest at Randwick. Aussie Helpers, Racing NSW, Godolphin and the NSW Trainers Association have also supported the foundation's first round of relief.

New Zealand

Per Incanto to stand for an increased fee

Per Incanto (Street Cry) will stand at an increased service fee of NZ\$17,500 (plus GST) at Little Avondale Stud in 2019, having stood last season for NZ\$15,000 (plus GST). The fee increase comes off the back of a fantastic season for the son of Street Cry (Machiavellian), which saw him sire two new Group 1 winners, with Shadows Cast winning the Thorndon Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) and Santa Monica's victory in the Railway Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m). "The better credentialled books of mares he served when we increased his service fee are just getting to the track," said studmaster Sam Williams.

"His two-year-olds Glenda Goodwitch and Hastobegood look real Guineas types."

Time Test to stand for unchanged fee

Little Avondale shuttler Time Test (Dubawi), who covered his first book of mares at the New Zealand-based stud last year, will stand for an unchanged fee of NZ\$10,000 (plus GST). Nadeem (Redoute's Choice), the sire of five new stakes performers in 2018/19 including the Gore Guineas (Listed, 1335m) and Dunedin Guineas (Listed, 1500m) winner Air Max, will stand for a fee of NZ\$5,000 (plus GST).

Volpe Veloce chasing second Group 1 win

Last-start Group 2 winner Volpe Veloce (Foxwedge) will go in search of her second elite level victory when the Graham Richardsontrained filly lines up in tomorrow's New Zealand Thoroughbred Breeders' Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) at Te Aroha. "The Breeders' is a race I always look forward to," Richardson told Racing.com. "You look back over the years and all the good mares that have won it, Orchidra and Tudor Light and those good ones. It's a strong field but we know we've got a good one on our hands. I've never had one with a 105 rating before."

Sharrock chasing stakes double

Allan Sharrock will chase black-type at two venues in the coming days, with Sinarahma (Darci Brahma) set to tackle today's Manawatu Breeders Stakes (Gr 3, 2000m) at Awapuni and Our Hail Mary (Ocean Park) in line to contest the NZB Airfreight Stakes (Listed, 1600m) at Riccarton on Saturday

as both fillies look to make their respective stakes breakthroughs. "If they could both get black-type and both being from the good mare's (Shez Sinsational) family, then they become very valuable broodmare prospects," Sharrock said. "They are both going well. We've got Johnathan Parkes on both and we are happy to have him on too."

Thurlow underwhelmed with Glory Days hit-out

Waverley trainer Bill Thurlow was not entirely pleased with Auckland Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) winner Glory Days' (Red Giant) gallop at Wanganui yesterday. The progressive stayer remains on track for the Sydney Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) on April 13, but Thurlow felt the six-year-old mare, who was partnered by Zinjete Moki, was over-extended early in her gallop. "It was alright, but I have seen her work better. It was just the circumstances I think, she just went a little bit hard early where she normally wouldn't," Thurlow said. Champion mare Vodka dies

Vodka (Tanino Gimlet), a three-time champion in her native Japan, has died aged 15 after vets were unable to save her following a bout of laminitis. Trained by Katsuhiko Sumii, Vodka earned the first of her seven Grade 1 victories at two when she landed the Hanshin Juvenile Fillies (Gr 1, 1600m). In the following year she became only the third filly in history to win the Japanese Derby (Gr 1, 2400m). The mare, who was inducted into the Japan Racing Association Hall of Fame in 2011, leaves a two-year-old Frankel (Galileo) colt, who was unsold at 285,000gns at last year's Tattersalls December Yearling Sale, and a filly foal by the same sire born in January.



High-class mares catalogued for Magic Millions National Broodmare Sale

high-class band of mares have been catalogued for the Magic Millions National Broodmare Sale on the Gold Coast on May 28, which is headed by dual Group 1 winner Global Glamour (Star Witness), who will be offered in foal to Widden Stud stallion Zoustar (Northern Meteor).

Global Glamour was confirmed as an entry for the Queensland sale by her connections last month and yesterday the auction house released a small sample of entries they have received for the sale, with the full catalogue due to be released in the coming weeks.

"This is a small sample of what our catalogue will provide this year," Barry Bowditch, Magic Millions managing director, told ANZ Bloodstock News yesterday. "Not only have the vendors given us a huge lot of mares, but they have given us a heap of quality as well, which we are grateful for.

"It sets us up nicely to attract a huge international and domestic market to the sale in late May.

"This is merely just a taste test to let people know that there is a lovely lot of mares to be offered at the Gold Coast. In that 60 there are none that you wouldn't want to own and that is just a very small sample (of what we have got to offer)."

Bowditch added he was delighted to secure Global Glamour for the sale, which would be somewhat of a homecoming for the mare given that she was sold by the auction house for \$65,000 in 2015.

"It is fantastic to be able to be part of the end of Global Glamour's story, which started with us at Magic Millions," said Bowditch. "I think she is going to be extremely popular, especially given that she is in foal to Zoustar."

"She is a quality looking mare, she is a Group 1 winner and in foal to one of the hottest stallions in the country. She will command a lot of attention."

Another mare that is set to garner a lot of attention is Erato (Street Cry) - the dam of this year's Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Lyre (Lonhro).



Erato herself is an exceptionally well-bred daughter of Street Cry (Machiavellian) and Group 1-winner come blue hen producer Mnemosyne (Encosta De Lago), making Erato a half-sister to dual Group 1 winner Impending (Lonhro), Group 3 winner Forget (Exceed And Excel) and Listed winner Epidemic (Lonhro). She will be offered in foal to Newgate Farm's exciting young sire Russian Revolution (Snitzel).

"Erato is the dam of undoubtedly one of the top two-year-old fillies of the season in foal to a very commercial first season horse in Russian Revolution," said Bowditch.

"We have seen what these mares have made (in the sales ring) when they have produced a top young horse, like Listen Here [who is the dam of Deep Field and Shooting To Win]. These mares are hard to find and they rarely come on the market, Group 1-producing mares, especially the age she is."

Other standout producers catalogued for the sale are Lipari (Redoute's Choice), the dam of Group 1 winner Levendi (Pierro) and Group 3 winner Marcel From Madrid (Sepoy) who will go under the hammer in foal to I Am Invincible

(Invincible Spirit), while Set To Unleash (Reset), the dam of high-class mare Houtzen (I Am Invincible), is carrying a full sibling to the Group 2 winner.

Group 1 winner Miss Cover Girl (Monashee Mountain), who was withdrawn from last year's edition of this sale, is another mare set to be offered in foal to I Am Invincible.

An intriguing lot set to take to the Magic Millions ring for the second time in as many years is Dee Nine Elle (Duporth), who was purchased at the sale by Kitchwin Hills for \$180,000. She is out of Sin Sin Sin (Fantastic Light) and has therefore been subject to a significant pedigree update since her last sale, with her half-sister Yes Yes (Rubick) having won the Todman Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) earlier in the season.

Dee Nine Elle will be offered in foal to Coolmore's Group 1-winning sire Merchant Navy (Fastnet Rock).

Meanwhile, Group 1 winner Miss Wilson (Stratum) will be offered in foal to Widden Stud's Zoustar. Miss Wilson is out of Cierzo (Centaine) making her a half-sister to multiple Group 1 winner and successful sire Jimmy Choux (Thorn Park).

The race fillies are headed by Myer Classic (registered as Empire Rose Stakes) (Gr 1, 1600m) winner I Am A Star (I Am Invincible) and she will be joined by another daughter of the Yarraman Park sire, Group 3 winner Invincible Star.

The catalogue also includes Group 2 winners Whispering Brook (Hinchinbrook), Sedanzer (Sebring), Savapinski (Savabeel), Quilista (Scandal Keeper), Oregon's Day (Domesday) and Gift Of Power (Power).

Meanwhile Eckstein (I Am Invincible), Dainty Tess (War Chant), Ellicazoom (Testa Rossa),

Bowditch said he was happy with the quality of race fillies set to be offered at the sale and he is very confident that it is a catalogue with a global appeal.

"We have got 1100 mares to offer, over 200 race fillies on day one including the likes of I Am A Star, Missrock and Gift Of Power," Bowditch said. "I could go through and name them all day but there is a huge amount of quality in our race fillies section.

"You know when these mares enter the ring that the big stallion owners, not only here in Australia, but worldwide, are focusing their attention and earmarking these mares to buy.

"They won't only just stay here in Australia, they will go all over the world after the sale. It is a global sale now and it is the epicentre of the market here in the southern hemisphere. We are truly grateful for the level of support the vendors have given us once again."

The full weanling and broodmare catalogue will be released in late April and the yearling catalogue soon after.

Inglis sales ring

o say the 450 youngsters entered for the 2019 Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale represent the best of the best is not simply promotional spin but is a realistic assessment of the pedigree quality on offer at Riverside Stables.

It will be a real selection test for intending buyers as almost every lot demands inspection being sons and daughters of top sires or by such well credentialled first-crop stallions as Exosphere (Lonhro), Kermadec (Teofilo), No Nay Never (Scat Daddy), Pride of Dubai (Street Cry), Real Impact (Deep Impact) and Vancouver (Medaglia D'Oro).

Buyers from around the world appreciate that recent graduates of this sale include Group 1 winners such as The Autumn Sun (Redoute's Choice), Estijaab (Snitzel), Merchant Navy (Fastnet Rock), Russian Revolution (Snitzel), Mossfun (Mossman), Flying Artie (Artie Schiller)

and Pinot (Pierro) and some of these top-class racehorses have close relatives catalogued this year.

Last year at Easter in Book 1 some 335 youngsters were sold for \$116,457,500 at an average of \$347,634. The median price was \$250,000 but there were many opportunities to buy nice horses in the \$70,000 to \$150,000 price range even though the sale's top seller - a brother to three-time Group 1 winner Shoals (Fastnet Rock) - sold for \$2.3 million.

In 2019 the catalogue features siblings to 39 Group 1 winners and yearlings out of 34 Group 1-winning mares such as Brazilian Pulse (Captain Rio), Hasna (Snippets), River Dove (Hurricane Sky),Our Egyptian Raine (Desert Sun), Pear Tart (Dehere), Rostova (Testa Rossa) and Steps in Time (Danehill Dancer).

Of the leading stallions, twice champion sire Snitzel (Redoute's Choice) has the biggest representation with 37 entries while the recently deceased Sebring (More Than Ready) has 33

entries, Fastnet Rock (Danehill) has 30 lots and I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit) has 28 of his progeny on offer.

Three times champion sire Redoute's Choice (Danehill), who died last month, has an impressive team of 20, Zoustar (Northern Meteor) and Medaglia d'Oro (El Prado) each have 18 lots to sell, while So You Think (High Chaparral) has 17 to tempt buyers.

First crop sires with large drafts are Vancouver (Medaglia d'Oro) with 23 and Pride of Dubai (Street Cry), who is represented by 20 yearlings. Adding spice for buyers there are also yearlings by such renowned international sires as Deep Impact (Sunday Silence), Frankel (Galileo), Tapit (Pulpit), Lord Kanaloa (King Kamehameha) and Harbinger (Dansili).

We are fortunate to consign for Fairway Thoroughbreds, Sheikh Mohammed bin Khalifa, YuLong, Amelia Park, Owen Egan and Chris and Jane Braham, who are all exemplary breeders and, along with our own horses, I am certain there is an array of superbly bred horses by proven stallions to suit all buyers. Pride Of Dubai (Street Cry) is a horse we have supported strongly and the two fillies out of Jezzabba (Fastnet Rock) (Lot 70) and Fiorentina (Dubai Destination) (Lot 9) will highlight what athletes this young stallion can throw.

Of your colts which is / are your standout / standouts?

Merchant Navy's brother out of Legally Bay (Snippets) (Lot 88), Catch Me's brother out of Captivating Claire (O'Reilly) (Lot 396) and the Snitzel (Redoute's Choice) out of Peron (Husson) (Lot 175) are the three standout colts on price. But I do also love the Redoute's Choice (Danehill) out of Comaneci (High Chaparral) (Lot 409) and the Sebring (More Than Ready) colt out of Diamond Glow (Bel Esprit) (Lot 427). They are all by proven stallions with the looks and pedigree to match, and they all move like panthers.

Of your fillies which is / are your standout / standouts?

I am in love with the So You Think (High Chaparral) - Celebrities Choice (Redoute's Choice) (Lot 400) filly, who has been a queen since the day she drew breath and I would rob a bank to buy her myself. We are blessed with superb fillies but if I had a gun to my head I would choose the Pride Of Dubai out of Jezzaba and the Lonhro (Octagonal) out of Houston Benefactor (Encosta De Lago) (Lot 47) - but quite honestly the group are impossible to split.

Which lot do you think has improved most since the beginning of the prep?

The Medaglia d'Oro (El Prado) colt out of Fireworks (Snitzel) (Lot 11) has simply transformed. He has always been a dance master to walk but in prep the boy has become a man. His mother did the exact same thing as a young horse and went on to win the Widden Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m).

How do you think the sale statistics will compare to the 2018 renewal?

The catalogue speaks for itself with an emphasis on quality as ever, even with Books 1 and 2 combined. The top echelon will always look after themselves and particular credit has to go to Sebastian Hutch and Johnathan D'Arcy who are doing exemplary work highlighting the fact that there are good horses for all budgets at Easter and all you have to do is see the likes of Mossfun (Mossman), Flying Artie (Artie Schiller), Egg Tart (Sebring) and Aristia (Lonhro), all of whom made under a \$100,000, to know that there is a good horse in all brackets at Easter.

Statistically I can see their hard work lift the averages of the lower to middle market which was the achilles heel last year and with the top holding firm I can't see why the sale won't be a belter as always.

Who do you think will be the leading sire at the sale?

As ever it will be a race between I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit), Fastnet Rock (Danehill) and Snitzel. I have seen some magnificent stock by all concerned - I think Snitzel by gross and Vinny by average

For anyone visiting Sydney for the first time, which restaurant would you recommend and what should they order?

Catalina at Rose Bay as it not only encompasses the beauty of the harbour but also has a superb menu and wine list, which is very important! I am not the best person to recommend food as I may be known as fussy - so grab a bottle of Hill Of Grace and the rest is academic.

Madison County runs the fastest last 600 metres at Saturday's Rosehill meeting

he New Zealand 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Madison County (Pins) produced the fastest final 600 metres at Rosehill on Saturday in coming from back in the field to take second in the Tulloch Stakes (Gr 2, 2000m).

Settling in second last place in the ninehorse field, Madison County then ran on, getting to within two lengths of the all-the-way winner Angel Of Truth (Animal Kingdom).

Having his second Australian start and racing on a heavy 10 track, Madison County was the only horse all day to break 36 seconds for the final 600 metres by clocking 35.90 seconds for that section.

Post-race, jockey Tommy Berry said that Madison County should have won and conceded that he made a costly mistake at the home turn.

Fearing the leaders would tire in the home straight, Berry felt his best prospects were to switch deep at that stage, saying later that he would have won had he stayed closer to the rails.

In addition, the moderate mid-race pace (even allowing for the heavy conditions) resulted in the 1000 metres (from the 1800m to the 800m) being clocked in only 1:05.11 (13.02 200m rate), which made the task of runners back in the field even more difficult.

The Gwenda Markwell-trained winner Angel Of Truth, a winner of three races at Kembla Grange from six starts prior to Saturday's contest, caused somewhat of a surprise in advancing rapidly in class by winning the Group 2 race, but he obviously appreciated stepping up in distance and also the rain-affected conditions.

Angel Of Truth fought off a raft of challengers at the home turn and saw out the 2000 metre trip well, also running home in a good time (for the conditions) of 36.18 for his final 600 metres.

Both Madison County and Angel Of Truth are to back-up quickly and will meet again

Her task was also made more difficult when the leader Greysful Glamour (Stratum) clocked only 54.64 (13.66 200m rate) for the

800 metre section from the 1400 metres to the 600 metres.

But Verry Ellegant responded well, despite the race turning into a sprint for home, returning a smart (for the heavy conditions) time for her final 600 metres of 36.80.

Settling better, racing in ear-muffs and without a nose roll, Verry Elleegant ran on strongly out wide in the straight to win by almost two lengths, claiming favouritism for the upcoming ATC Australian Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) in the process.

It was Verry Elleegant's fifth win in ten starts and her first at Group 1 level, while her rider James McDonald later spoke confidently about her coping well with the advance to 2400 metres for her next Group 1 target at Randwick on Saturday week.

The runner-up, the Kris Lees-trained filly Frankley Awesome (Frankel) also deserves acknowledgement as she too came from back in the field and did well in finishing a length and three-quarters from the winner, clocking 36.89 for her final 600 metres.

The other Group 1 feature, the H E Tancred Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) was taken out by Godolphin's talented British-bred stayer **Avilius** (Pivotal), where he too made light of a pedestrian early pace in winning impressively by just over two lengths.

After the leaders clocked only 1:32.39 (13.19 200m rate) from the 1400 metre section (from the 2200m to the 800m, Avilius needed to show a very good turn of foot to score - he did and he did it easily, clocking 48.87 (last 800m),

36.67 (last 600m) and 24.59 for his final 400 metres.

Avilius is now the winner of eight of his last 11 starts in Australia, with the Tancred Stakes being his second Group 1 success following on only a fortnight after winning the Ranvet Stakes (registered as Rawson Stakes) (Gr 1, 2000m) at Rosehill on March 23.

While the focus of the column so far has been the lack of genuine tempos (even allowing for the heavy track) the opposite applied in the victory of the Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott-trained colt **Bellevue Hill** (Pierro) in the opening race on the card.

Stepping up to 1400 metres, at his third start, Bellevue Hill went to the front and set a solid pace throughout before taking out The Schweppervescence (registered as T L Baillieu Handicap) (Gr 3, 1400m) comfortably by two lengths in a time of 1:28.21 on the heavy 10 track.

The feature of Bellevue Hill's win was the mid-sectional times he recorded.


