Dual Group 1 winner Harry Angel to shuttle to Darley Australia

Son of Dark Angel to stand at Kelvinside in New South Wales for a fee of \$22,000

Champion sprinter Harry Angel (Dark Angel) will shuttle to Darley's Kelvinside base in New South Wales this year, where he will stand for an introductory fee of \$22,000 (inc GST).

Having shed his maiden tag in the Mill Reef Stakes (Gr 2, 6f) on just his second career start, Harry Angel announced himself as a top-rank sprinter with a stunning victory in the Sandy

Lane Stakes (Gr 2, 6f) as a three-year-old, after which he was acquired privately by Sheikh Mohammed's Godolphin operation.

The son of Dark Angel (Acclamation) went on to make his Group 1 breakthrough in the July Cup (Gr 1, 6f) at Newmarket before a sensational performance in Haydock's Sprint Cup (Gr 1, 6f) saw him account for a top-class field, which included Group 1 winners Blue Point (Shamardal), The Tin Man (Equiano) and Brando (Pivotal), by an emphatic four lengths.

Waikato Stud announce 2019 fees as Savabeel spearheads five-strong roster

Waikato Stud stalwart Savabeel (Zabeel) will work from a closed book for the 2019 southern hemisphere breeding season, a move that will see the champion sire cover a reduced number of mares this year.

Savabeel has enjoyed another landmark season both on the track and in the sales ring, siring 18 individual stakes winners and achieving his highest-priced yearling at the Karaka Yearling Sale in January, where Te Akau principal David Ellis parted with NZ\$1.4 million for a colt by the rising 18-year-old.

<< *Continued from page 1* Trained throughout his career by Clive Cox, Harry Angel returned at four to land the Duke Of York Stakes (Gr 2, 6f) under a penalty before rounding off his career with a gallant second to Sands Of Mali (Panis) in the British Champions Sprint Stakes (Gr 1, 6f).

The dual Group 1 winner began his stud career earlier this year at Dalham Hall in Newmarket as the highest-rated sprinter to take up stallion duties in Britain for more than 30 years.

"Harry Angel is a high-end sprinter whose precocity will work well in this part of the world," Godolphin Australia's Managing Director, Vin Cox, said.

"We have been to have a look at him and were very impressed with him on type. We're sure he's the sort that Australian buyers will like.

"We will be supporting him with Godolphin mares and expect him to get off to a good start."

Harry Angel is out of the placed-mare Beatrix Potter - a daughter of fellow July Cup winner Cadeaux Genereux (Young Generation) - who is a half-sister to dual Hong Kong Group 1 hero Xtension (Xaar) and a three-quarter-sister to the stakes-placed A Huge Dream (Refuse To Bend), herself the dam of dual-Listed winner Mrs Gallagher (Oasis Dream).

As well as possessing an outcross pedigree with just one line of Danzig (Northern Dancer) in the fifth generation, Harry Angel is the best-performed son of Dark Angel and ended his three-year-old season rated 132 by Timeform - level with Muhaarar (Oasis Dream) and the best by any sprinter to retire to stud in Britain since 1985.

The panel of international handicappers duly assessed him the world champion sprinter in 2017, two or more points above Battaash (Dark Angel), Chautauqua (Encosta De Lago), Lady Aurelia (Scat Daddy), Redzel (Snitzel) and Caravaggio (Scat Daddy).

Darley Head Of Sales, Alastair Pulford, added. "He was the world's best sprinter in a year when there were a lot of good sprinters going around, particularly in Australia.

"The international handicappers rated him better than Chautauqua, better than Redzel and better than Vega Magic."

Harry Angel is the second new recruit to Darley's stallion roster for the 2019 southern hemisphere breeding season after it was announced that Kementari (Lonhro) would stand for an introductory fee of \$33,000 (inc GST) following his retirement last month.

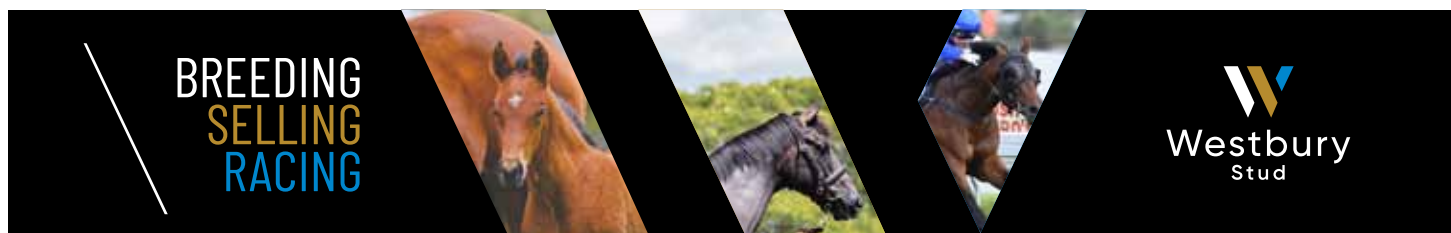

Rain holds off in Sydney

Day two of The Championships is set to begin on a Soft 5 surface following a dry week in Sydney, while there is a chance the going description could improve to a Soft 4 later today. The lucky fans who have managed to obtain a ticket for the sell-out showpiece are set to be rewarded with pleasant viewing conditions as the weather is set fair and sunny, with the temperature forecast to be in the mid-20 degrees.

Webster will be pleased with second

Happy Clapper (Teofilo) will face Winx for the 11th time in his career in today's Queen Elizabeth Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) and trainer Pat Webster is hoping he can occupy the runner-up spot behind the wondermare once again. "She's a freak," Webster said. "But I'd like to think the Clapper can run second. I'm hoping for top four at least and he has always done his best to be competitive. It hasn't paid off as far as beating her and I've put the white flag up. I surrender. Second is what I'm hoping for."

Improvement expected from Danzdzandance

Co-trainer Chris Gibbs is anticipating an improved performance from Ranvet Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) third Danzdzandance (Mastercraftsman) in the Queen Elizabeth, for which she is a \$31 chance. "She got back a little bit further than what we would have liked and ended up in the worst part of the track (in the Ranvet)," Gibbs said. "When she over-raced that made it a little bit harder. I was quite pleased that she sprinted as well as she did to finish third and there was a nice gap between her and fourth. We only need to have improved a little bit I think to be somewhere in the finish."

Scarlet Dream ready to step up in Oaks

Mark Newnham has issued a positive bulletin on ATC Australian Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) contender Scarlet Dream (Sebring) and is anticipating that the Vinery Stud Stakes (registered as the Storm Queen Stakes) (Gr 1, 2000m) seventh will appreciate the extra distance. "She was probably a little disappointing to the eye in the Vinery, but it was a Heavy 10 and she was back last and had to come wide," Newnham said. "It's never a good recipe at Rosehill and certainly not when it's heavy and the rail is out six metres. Her work on Monday was as good as you'd like and I'm sure a mile-and-a-half and a big track is what she's been looking for."

Young hoping for first Group 1

Co-trainers Trent Busuttin and Natalie Young will have two chances at Randwick this afternoon - Maracaibo (Redoute's Choice) in the Australian Oaks and Semari (Sebring) in the Sydney Cup (Gr, 3200m) - as they bid to win their first Group 1 win since relocating to Australia. "It would be great if we could get a Group 1," Young said. "We've been trying and been knocking at the door the last couple of years since moving here, so it would be nice to just get one of them up. You've got to have a crack."

Kenedna set for Legacy

Co-trainer David Eustace is anticipating a bold showing from Kenedna (Not A Single Doubt) in the Coolmore Legacy Stakes (registered as the Queen Of The Turf Stakes) (Gr 1, 1600m) at Randwick today. "It was a massive run last-start (third in the Sunline Stakes) and she worked great at Caulfield on Tuesday morning," Eustace said. "She is in as good an order as we can get the horse. We haven't had her a long time but I think she's going to hit peak form third-up. She's just got the ideal gate for her. We don't need to be in any rush but she's not going to get too far back from barrier eight. So fingers crossed."

Conditions should suit Yogi

Eustace has also spoken positively regarding Sydney Cup hopeful Yogi (Raise The Flag), who was last seen running fifth in the Tancred Stakes (Gr 1, 2400m), while the six-year-old was a dual Listed winner for former trainer Darren Weir. "He's a thorough stayer, which you're going to need to be in that race," Eustace said. "It's probably going to be a full field and a bit of a stamina test of course, so at least he's got that on his side. He's in good order and this has been his target."

Improving track should also suit Rondinella

Co-trainer Roger James believes his Sydney Cup contender Rondinella (Ocean Park) will be well-suited by the drying track conditions, with the four-year-old having run third in the Tancred Stakes (Gr 1, 2400m) on her latest outing. He said: "It is good form and all on tracks that were basically against her, because they were all rain-affected. Avilius is unbeaten in Sydney and I think unbeaten on heavy tracks, so to run him that close I thought the run was tremendous. I am very happy with her. At the back of my mind I wonder if she is six months away from full maturity - it's also a bit of an unknown whether she will get the two miles."

High hopes for Classique Legend

Les Bridge believes the future is bright for Munro Stakes (Listed, 1200m) third Classique Legend (Not A Single Doubt), who is set to line up in the Arrowfield 3YO Sprint (registered as the Royal Sovereign Stakes) (Gr 2, 1200m) at Randwick today. Reflecting on his latest start, Bridge said: "He got out there and they kicked up on the inside. He just wasn't travelling well enough in the going to press on and lead, so he (Kerrin McEvoy, jockey) just tried to hold him together. I gave him three weeks to get over it. I guess you never know until you back them up but to me, I think he's fine."

Avantage ready for Sprint

The Jamie Richards-trained Avantage (Fastnet Rock), who has won seven of her eight outings - including the Sires' Produce Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Manawatu as a juvenile - is in good shape heading into today's Arrowfield 3YO Sprint. "Avantage had a nice walk at the beach this morning and she's ready to run well on Saturday," Richards said yesterday. "The ground should be dead, so everything will get their chance. Drawn barrier five, she's equal favourite in a race with a lot of depth. There's quite a few three-year-olds dropping back from the weight-for-age sprints."

Three for Waugh

Also at Randwick, Kim Waugh will have three runners in the Provincial Championships Final (1400m) after second emergency Fuchu (All Too Hard) was granted a start following the defection of the Greg McFarlane-trained It's So Obvious (Krupt) because of an unsatisfactory blood profile. Fuchu will join stable companions Spring Charlie (Myboycharlie) and Safado (Lonhro) in the \$500,000 contest, with \$5.50 chance Spring Charlie, who has won five of his nine outings, the shortest-priced of the trio.

Miss Leonidas steps up

Miss Leonidas (I Am Invincible) will return to stakes company when the three-time winner contests the Bel Esprit Stakes (Listed, 1100m) at Caulfield this afternoon. Miss Leonidas has drawn barrier nine in the 12-horse field and will be partnered by Joe Bowditch, who rode the mare first-up at Mornington. "I'm disappointed with the barrier but I'm confident she'll run well," trainer Shaun Dwyer said. "Joey will have a much better idea about her after riding her at Mornington last time."

Super Seth favourite

Also at Caulfield, the Anthony Freedman-trained Super Seth (Dundeel) will try to build on his six-length debut success at Ballarat when he lines up in the Ern Jensen Funerals Handicap (1200m). "He did a really good job on debut and he's a really nice colt going forward," Freedman's son and assistant trainer, Sam, said. "He's shown above-average ability and just at the moment we're really teaching him about the game. He still does a little bit wrong

and is still a little bit keen, but he has got very good raw ability. Once we can harness it, hopefully he can end up a really nice horse."

Wagga Cup next for Willi

The Craig Widdison-trained Willi Willi (Mint Lane) will test his Wagga Wagga Gold Cup (Listed, 2000m) credentials when he lines up in the Manhari Metals Handicap (1600m) at Caulfield today. "He was meant to go around in the Golden Mile at Bendigo (March 30) but didn't get a run," Widdison said. "So we don't want too much to go wrong between now and the Wagga Cup timing wise. I'm happy enough with him and he'll run well enough this week."

Derby hopefuls resume

Queensland Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) hopefuls A Man To Match (High Chaparral) and Trusty Lad (Reliable Man) will begin their winter carnival campaigns when they line up in the Three-Year-Old Handicap (1400m) at Eagle Farm today. Tony Gollan said of A Man To Match: "He has \$124,000, which is a big start to getting into the winter races. Whether he is up to them we will see but he should get a chance to show what he can do."

New Zealand

Vale Dick Bothwell

Successful Taranaki trainer Dick Bothwell died this week aged 72. Bothwell, who retired from training in 2017, was based at Stratford for more than 40 years and won more races at the racecourse than any other trainer. Bothwell's son, Chris, trained in partnership with his father for 20 years and took over the stable when Dick retired. Among those to pay tribute to Bothwell was Auckland-based Leigh McKenzie, who part-owned quality fillies Love To Dance (Citidance) and Moralee (Desert Sun). "I knew him for a long time and never heard a bad word said about him," McKenzie said. Bothwell is survived by his wife Jilly, his three children Chris, Richard and Dale, and two grandchildren.

Woodcote Lass impresses in maiden win

The Stephen Autridge-trained Woodcote Lass (Showcasing) is set to step up into stakes company following her length and a quarter success in the NZB Insurance 2YO Maiden

Stakes (1230m) at Rotorua yesterday. "She does show a fair bit," Autridge said. "We did have some concerns of whether she would handle the track (Slow 9). She drew four, kept a bit wide and ended up in the best place. At the 600 metres there were a few behind us that looked like they were coming into it, but they were doing overtime in the bad ground and we were out in the better ground going well."

Marsh has high hopes for Felaar

Stephen Marsh is brimming with enthusiasm as he prepares to saddle three-time winner Felaar (Ekraar) in the Hawke's Bay Cup (Listed, 2200m) this afternoon. "I'm really big on Felaar," Marsh said. "He's got blinkers on for the first time and has drawn nicely and at the weights, with 53 kilograms, I think he is a massive chance."

Asia

Lor hopes it's Party time again

The Frankie Lor-trained Big Party (Exceed And Excel) will try to complete the hat-trick and make it three wins from four starts when he returns from an injury-induced layoff at Sha Tin on Sunday. "For me, he's in good form," the trainer said. "He's an exciting horse. In the morning he's really relaxed but when he goes to the race or in a trial he's trying to go really hard, he wants to go too hard. That's why these little problems come up."

Harley extends his Hong Kong stint

Martin Harley has had his contract to ride in Hong Kong extended until the end of the season, meaning the rider will not return to Britain until July. Harley, 29, was initially given a three-month contract to ride in Hong Kong in February and has since ridden two winners, a second and four thirds during his stint. The Group 1-winning rider, who has primarily been used by trainers Tony Millard, Ricky Yiu and Caspar Fownes during his time abroad, is excited about the rest of his first season in Hong Kong. He said: "It's really exciting and I hope I can kick on over the next three months having laid some solid foundations and networks during my time so far."

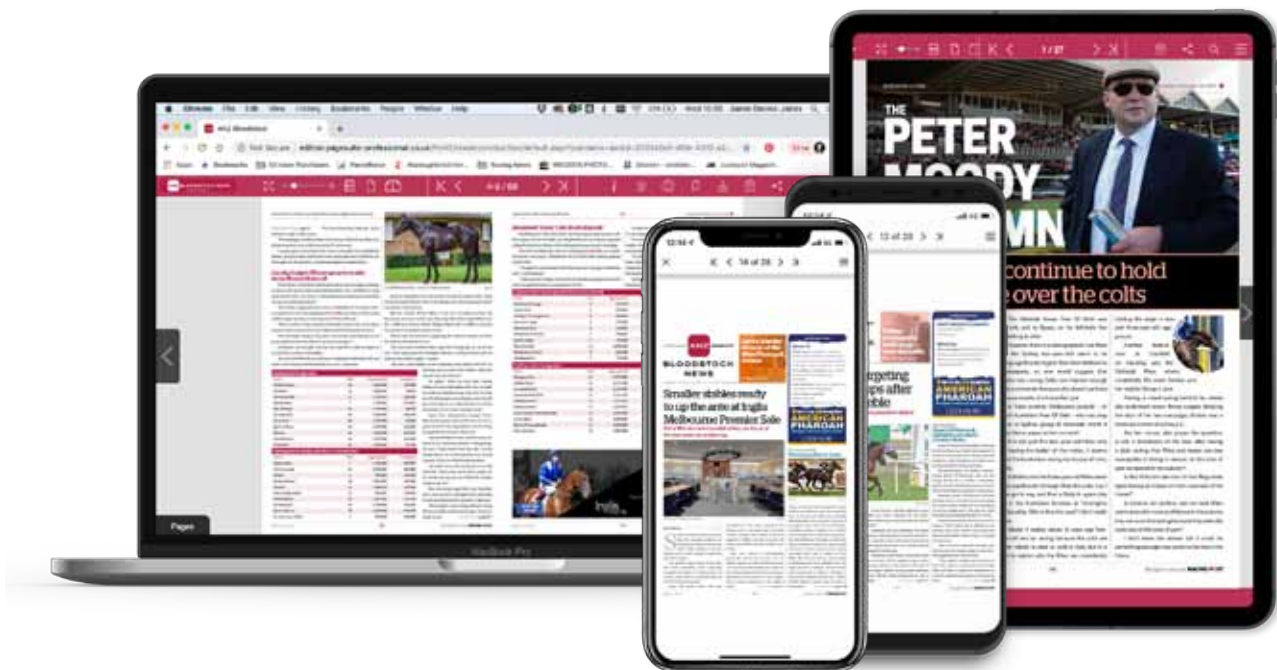

Woodside Park shuttler Cable Bay (Invincible Spirit) was provided with his second northern

hemisphere winner yesterday when Visayas (2 f ex Palais Polaire by Polar Falcon) landed the Premio Amur (1000m) at Rome. Trained by Melania Cascione and ridden by Giuseppe Ercegovic, the filly beat Fiorerosa (Alhebayeb), with Amarsi Un Po (Zebedee) in third. Moments earlier, another of Cable Bay's daughters, Separate, finished a close second at Newbury, meaning the stallion has had three runners for two winners and a second. Cable Bay is currently standing at Highclere Stud in Britain for a fee of £6,500.

Progeny of Anodin popular at Osarus

Haras du Quesnay's Anodin (Anabaa), who has his first three-year-olds on the

track this year, was the leading sire of the Osarus Breeze-Up Sale at Le Teste racecourse on Thursday, where the emerging stallion was responsible for two of the top three lots. Both the two-year-olds were consigned by Paul Basquin's Haras du Saubouas and bought by Christophe Ferland, who had to go to a sale-topping €90,000 to secure **Lot 42**, named Night Of Love, a daughter of Anodin who cost just €17,000 as a yearling at the Arqana October Sale. She is a half-sister to the talented Hello My Love (Literato), second in the Prix Daniel Wildenstien (Gr 2, 1600m), and from the Classic German family of Group 1 winner and sire Lord Of England (Dashing Blade).

Waikato Stud announce 2019 fees as Savabeel spearheads five-strong roster

Waikato Stud stalwart Savabeel (Zabeel) will work from a closed book for the 2019 southern hemisphere breeding season, a move that will see the champion sire cover a reduced number of mares this year.

Savabeel has enjoyed another landmark season both on the track and in the sales ring, siring 18 individual stakes winners and

achieving his highest-priced yearling at the Karaka Yearling Sale in January, where Te Akau principal David Ellis parted with NZ\$1.4 million for a colt by the rising 18-year-old.

His sale average over all Australasian yearling sales in 2019 has been NZ\$305,000 from 55 sold - his highest to date - while Group 1 winners for the stallion this season include Shillelagh, Savvy Coup and Nicoletta, who landed the New Zealand Thoroughbred

Breeders Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) last weekend to take Savabeel's tally of top-tier winners to 18.

"We are absolutely thrilled with Savabeel, who has had one of his most successful seasons to date," Waikato Stud's Mark Chittick said.

"However, as he enters the twilight years of his stud career, he will cover a lesser number of mares this season and we will be making a conscious effort to manage him carefully."

Elsewhere on the Waikato roster, emerging young sire Sacred Falls (O'Reilly) will be available to breeders at NZ\$20,000 (plus GST), with Tivaci (High Chaparral), whose first foals arrived on the ground last year, also set to stand for the same fee.

Meanwhile Rock 'N' Pop (Fastnet Rock), who was handed his first stakes winner earlier this year courtesy of Surely Sacred's Auckland Guineas (Gr 2, 1600m) victory, will stand for NZ\$7,000 (plus GST), with Ocean Park (Thorn Park) - the sire of Group 1 placegetters Arrogant, Rondinella, Another Dollar and Mongolianconqueror - set to command a fee of NZ\$15,000 (plus GST).

The leading New Zealand-based second-season sire in Australia last season, Ocean Park has produced a stakes winners-to-runners rate of 33 per cent when put over mares on the Danehill (Danzig) cross, while his Book 1 yearlings sold for up to NZ\$220,000 - at an average price of NZ\$90,000 - at Karaka earlier this year.

"Ocean Park continues to impress us with his immense success and consistent results, particularly in Australia. We hope that the revision of his service fee makes Ocean Park more accessible for breeders," Chittick added.

"The revision of our stallion fees for 2019 is partly market-driven, but a significant driving factor behind the decision is Waikato Stud's determination to offer breeders the opportunity to breed the best racehorses possible at great value.

Waikato Stud is renowned for giving our stallions the highest quality of life on our farm, so they have every chance of success. We are looking forward to another busy breeding season and invite inspections at any stage."

Anyhow "have a Winfield" as Paul Hogan immortalised and it probably is her final run and God bless her that she makes it 33 straight and a 25th Group 1 win. Win or lose, she has put together the greatest winning streak in racing history - far more significant than some of those bizarre examples tossed up from

South America and greater than the wonderful Hungarian mare Kincsem's 54 straight, almost 150 years ago, which was sprinkled with walkovers and cakewalks.

A greater streak than Black Caviar's 25 on end although I would still argue that Black Caviar is the best-performed horse of all time given that she was unbeaten racing on a legitimate stage. Read my words. Best-performed, not necessarily the best.

That lack of sleep has made me grumpy as well so I'm just in the mood to launch into everyone and everything, which I know is probably not a good idea...but what the heck, I'm on a runaway train!

There's a number of curiosities afoot at Randwick tomorrow. I'd like someone to tell me why on earth James Cummings is backing up the Golden Slipper winner Kiamichi in the Percy Sykes Stakes after running in the Inglis Sires' last Saturday?

She's had gut busting runs at her past two starts. Last week, her effort was herculean in the Sires'. Good heavens, she's got to carry the maximum penalty here and the team has four others in the race, a couple of whom would be

well served by a Group 2 win. James, just put her (Kiamichi) aside and she'll win everything there is to win in the spring.

Now we move on to Verry Elleegant. Could someone please tell me why her owners opted to give her the most ridiculous spelling?

I'd also like to know why she is such poisonous odds at little better than 1/2 in the Australian Oaks. As the track dries out, her price should be lengthening and she pulled her head off when stepped up to this distance range in the VRC Oaks last spring. She has to be a risk.

And what of the ridiculously short price being offered about Dubhe in the Sydney Cup. He won a very weak ratings race at this distance in Dubai. If he wasn't trained by Charlie Appleby, he'd be three times his current quote.

So, that's my rant. I have just stepped off a plane, by the way, and I'll wear the egg on face if Kiamichi and Very "whatit'sname" win as they are both extremely good fillies.

So where do we get a "quid" at a bit of value. I'm keen on Avantage and Trope in the Arrowfield Sprint with Charge not hopeless at likely odds of 50/1. The \$5 Avantage

looks attractive for a horse who's won seven of her eight starts and was outstanding on her Australian debut. Trope is certainly capable of winning if the race sets up for the closers.

The Oaks is an incredibly open race for one which has an odds-on favourite. If this track gets anywhere near close to good then the VRC Oaks winner Aristia just might claim a second classic.

But nothing would shock me about Brenton Avdulla winning another Oaks on a 100/1 shot. This time on Miss Moana for the king of the staying fillies, John Sargent. The previous, of course, was for Lee Curtis on Lasqueti Spirit in the 2016 VRC Oaks.

Later in the day, I'll play Kenedna and Nakeeta Jane in the Coolmore Legacy Stakes. Kenedna was massive second-up at Moonee Valley and ready to win while Nakeeta Jane is back in trip after finishing fourth in the Vinery Stud Stakes - which is precisely the form of the past two winners of this race - Foxplay and Alizee.

Happy Clapper (Teofilo)

Summary: Einstein's maxim that insanity is best-defined as 'doing the same thing over and over again but expecting different results' might be applicable to Happy Clapper had he not accrued such a lucrative prize-money purse in his clashes with Winx,

despite the score standing at a resounding 0-11. The eight-year-old first met the mare when running fifth in the 2016 renewal of the George Ryder Stakes (Gr 1, 1500m) and he has faced her at distances ranging from 1400 metres to the 2040 metres of the Cox Plate (Gr 1) subsequently, including when receiving an enterprising ride in the Chipping Norton Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) this year. Blake Shinn changed tact with Happy Clapper on that occasion, grasping the nettle and setting solid early fractions which allowed

him to command a significant advantage passing through the 600-metre marker. For a fleeting moment he looked to have stolen a march, but he was unable to sustain his effort in the closing stages and eventually succumbed by a length and three quarters. While he brings some of the strongest recent form into the contest, Happy Clapper has always proved best over shorter and, aside from Winx, one or two might be finishing a bit stronger, especially if forward-going tactics are employed again.

Runner-up in the All-Star Mile (1600m) when conceding five kilograms to Mystic Journey (Needs Further), Hartnell ran another admirable race when lugging top-weight to third in last weekend's Doncaster Mile (Gr 1, 1600m), threatening to challenge as the tempo quickened but proving unable to match the acceleration of Brutal (O'Reilly) and Dreamforce (Fastnet Rock). Giving his staying prowess in Europe it is slightly surprising how little racing he has completed over 2000 metres in Australia, particularly under the care of James Cummings, but he's an admirable sort who will see the trip out well and he's an obvious choice for those looking to play the place market.

Summary: An impressive winner of a Newmarket maiden (1m) on his sole outing at two, He's Eminent - or then simply Eminent when racing under the care of Martyn Meade - held legitimate Classic aspirations in his three-year-old season, running admirable races to finish sixth in the 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1m) and fourth in the Derby (Gr 1, 1m4f) without having the touch of class required to prove a top-notch performer. Enterprisingly ridden by Ryan Moore in the Prix Guillaume d'Ornano (Gr 2, 2000m) at Deauville, the son of Frankel (Galileo) made all, stretched his rivals out down the back and never looked like being caught, winning by three lengths. Similar tactics were seen to good effect on his Australian debut in the Ranvet Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m), only finding Avilius (Pivotal) - who finished behind him under Andre

Fabre's watch at Deauville - too strong. A repeat of that forcing style would be highly-desirable this afternoon: we already know Winx can post lightning fractions off a strong gallop, so a solid early tempo might allow her to produce the most fitting of farewell performances, while it would be pleasing to see more substance added to the form of Avilius, who looks a star on the rise with a view to his spring campaign.

The four-year-old has shown improved form under the care of Ciaran Maher and David Eustace since, running his best race to finish a long-neck second in the Ajax Stakes (Gr 2, 1500m) on his penultimate start, but even accounting for potential improvement returned to this trip, it's hard to see him landing a blow at this level.

this afternoon and even the figure of Shillelagh is not too recognisable, with this being the first time she has tackled her most illustrious stable companion. Narrowly touched off by Harlem in the Australian Cup, the dual Group 1 winner is a talented mare in her own right, while she banished a disappointing run in the Ranvet Stakes when finishing a solid fifth in the Doncaster Mile last weekend. However, she would need to leave that form well behind if she was to add top-tier victory number three to her record this afternoon and it would prove a rather numbing set of circumstances if she was to rain on her very own stablemate's parade.



Verdict

James McDonald is almost assured to go forward on **He's Eminent** and a solid early gallop will hopefully allow Hugh Bowman to bide his time aboard **Winx** from stall nine, likely sitting somewhere between the two-path and the four-path before executing their typical circumnavigation of the field on the swing for home as the sell-out crowd are sure to explode into voice. He's Eminent has his optimum conditions and brings rock-solid credentials to the table, so he looks the choice for the quinella, and with question marks about just how good Happy Clapper is over this trip, the frame claims can be fought out between **Hartnell** and **Danzdanzdance**, with the former having stronger form, although third-place for the latter would pay handsome testament to the filly and her connections.

A look at the runners and riders

The remarkable racing career of Australian wondermare Winx (Street Cry) comes to an end today when she contests her last race, the Queen Elizabeth Stakes at Randwick (Gr 1, 2000m). But as one chapter closes, another begins and speculation is now rife as to which stallion will be appointed for her first mating.

Connections have remained tight-lipped about the seven-year-old's future in the paddocks, although her co-owners have indicated they are hoping to breed from her themselves.

"How could you sell a national treasure?" Peter Tighe remarked at the Longines-sponsored World's Best Racehorse ceremony in January, where Winx was recognised as the joint-highest rated performer of 2018 alongside Cracksman. "She's a national treasure in Australia.

"What she has done for us, I think it's only fitting that we make sure she has the best possible life after racing. Breeding is a new chapter. I'm not a breeder as such, I'm purely an owner, but I will make an exception for her."

With the co-owners not having let slip which stallions they might favour for their

history-making mare, the Daily Telegraph in Australia on Tuesday devoted its front page, adorned with pictures of hearts and roses, to the big question of the first mating.

We might not know the identity of which horse Tighe and his co-owners deem to be Mr Right, but we can safely assume it will be a blue-chip stallion with a high profile and a correspondingly expensive fee, earned through their achievements at stud, on the track or both.

Aside from that, all options are open. And there really are plenty of options, because Winx's pedigree makes her so easy to mate; she is by the late shuttle stallion Street Cry, who was by Machiavellian (Mr. Prospector) out of a mare by Troy (Petingo), and the sires of her first three dams are Al Akbar (Success Express), Voodoo Rhythm (Northern Dancer) and Sovereign Edition (Sovereign Path).

Extraordinarily, considering his ubiquity in Australian thoroughbred families, Danehill (Danzig) is nowhere to be seen on her page. Nor are the likes of Green Desert (Danzig), Last Tycoon (Try My Best), Sadler's Wells (Northern Dancer) or Zabeel (Sir Tristram).

Narrowing down the field of Winx's potential suitors is a tough assignment, then, but the most obvious place to start is Australia's leading stallions by progeny earnings of 2018/19.

Proven frontrunners

Leading the way, by a margin of more than \$6 million thanks to son Redzel's second win in the lavishly funded Everest, is Snitzel (Redoute's Choice). The son of the late Redoute's Choice (Danehill) must be the bookies' favourite to get first dibs on Winx as champion sire in Australia in 2016/17 and 2017/18 and the source of 13 Group 1 winners including the likes of Russian Revolution, Shamus Award and Trapeze Artist as well as Redzel.

Proponents of the cover by Snitzel, who stood at Arrowfield Stud at \$220,000 last year, might point to the fact that he is the sire of Winx's useful half-brother El Divino and that his Listed-winning son Sandbar, a close fourth to The Autumn Sun (Redoute's Choice) in the Golden Rose in September, is out of a mare by Street Cry.

I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit), one of the hottest sires in Australia in recent years, must also figure highly among Winx's co-owners' calculations.

The Yarraman Park Stud flagbearer has risen from relative obscurity and a lowest price of just \$11,000 to a blockbuster fee of \$192,500 after supplying Group 1 winners Brazen Beau, Hellbent, I Am A Star, Media Sensation, Oohood, Viddora and Voodoo Lad.

The son of Invincible Spirit (Green Desert) was the second most expensive stallion in Australia of 2018 and is second in the current season's sire standings, giving best only to Snitzel in both circumstances.

Coolmore's stalwart shuttler **Fastnet Rock** (Danehill) also deserves consideration, in fourth place behind Snitzel, I Am Invincible and Street Cry by prize-money in Australia for 2018/19 and with no other stallion currently standing down under able to match his tally of 36 top-level winners sired.

Darley's frequent flyer **Exceed And Excel** (Danehill) is another elder statesman and, like Fastnet Rock, a former Australian champion sire who should be in the running for the prize of Winx. He has 12 Group 1 winners to his name and is proving influential in the second generation of pedigrees, all while remaining more relevant than ever, as son Microphone's victory in this month's Inglis Sires' (registered as ATC Sires' Produce Stakes) (Gr 1, 1400m) proved.

Similarly, Exceed And Excel's studmate Lonhro (Octagonal) has achieved great things in both hemispheres – an Australian sire championship in the south, Gronkowski from fewer seasons in the north – and he would bring to the mix some esteemed Antipodean bloodlines. His sire Octagonal was by the great Zabeel out of record-setting broodmare Eight Carat (Pieces Of Eight), while Group 1 winners Niello (Octagonal), Lankan Rupee (Redoute's Choice) and Mahaya (Sir Tristram) are members of his maternal family.

The next generation

If Lonhro might be a little too much of an age mismatch for Winx – he is 13 years her senior – then perhaps the mare's co-owners might consider his exciting young son Pierro, who with three crops on the ground has delivered the Group 1 winners Arcadia Queen, Levendi and Pinot and last month's Hong Kong Derby (Listed, 2000m) victor Furore.

All Too Hard (Casino Prince), of the same vintage as Pierro, has not sired a Group 1 winner of his own yet and would probably only

have an outside chance of Winx visiting his court at Vinery Stud. But the mating would be quite pleasing from the point of view that it would unite the influences of Australia's two turf queens of the new millennium, the champion three-year-old All Too Hard being a half-brother to none other than Black Caviar (Bel Esprit).

Among the second-season stallions in Australia, **Zoustar** (Northern Meteor) stands head and shoulders above his peers, having been represented by the triple Group 1 winner Sunlight and four other Group scorers. He is in line for a big fee increase at Widden Stud for the coming season, and is rapidly developing the stature of the sort of stallion who would be a suitable match for Winx.

Of the other sophomores, **Spirit Of Boom** (Sequalo) has overachieved from the opportunities granted to him, and **Dundeel** (High Chaparral) is coming up on the rails as a useful sire, but both are likely longshots for receiving a mare of such high standing.

It's questionable whether any of the Australian freshmen have yet accomplished enough to merit being considered eligible bachelors for Winx, although the inexpensive **Sidestep** (Exceed And Excel) sent out a signal he might be better than his price-tag – \$7,700, up to \$22,000 this year – when first-crop daughter Kiamichi netted the Golden Slipper (Gr 1, 1200m) last month.

Unproven applicants

Conventional thinking dictates that outstanding racemares will be covered by proven stallions in their early years at paddocks. The reasoning is that combining two unknown quantities is too big a risk to take with such valuable commodities.

That is not to say mare owners don't enact such matings. Taghrooda (Sea The Stars) visited Kingman (Invincible Spirit) when both were in their debut seasons at stud, while Zarkava (Zamindar) went to Sea The Stars (Cape Cross) in his first year, after she had delivered her first foal, the same stages of their second careers that Treve (Motivator) and Shalaa (Invincible Spirit) were at when they met in 2017.

Foremost among the young stallions in Australia who might seduce Winx's owners into stepping into the unknown are the two US Triple Crown heroes who will be shuttling to Coolmore's Australian base this year, **American Pharoah** (Pioneerof The Nile) and **Justify** (Scat Daddy).

The chances of a mating with American Pharoah might increase if he gets off to a good start with his first northern hemisphere-bred two-year-olds in the coming months. As for Justify, there are a few clues on paper that the cross with Winx might click, as Justify's late

lamented sire Scat Daddy (Johannesburg) threw Moyglare Stud Stakes (Gr 1, 7f) winner Skitter Scatter and Royal Ascot scorer Con Te Partiro to other daughters of Street Cry.

The Autumn Sun, the five-time Group 1 winner by Redoute's Choice out of a Galileo (Sadler's Wells) mare from a top Aga Khan family, might also make shortlists now it has been confirmed he will retire to Arrowfield Stud at a fee of \$77,000.

The foreign legion

Winx's connections eschewed international competition for their superstar mare, as is their entitlement, so it has to be debatable whether they would ship her overseas for her first cover.

If they were minded to do so, top of the list might be Japan's champion sire **Deep Impact** (Sunday Silence), who is held in high esteem in Australia with offspring Real Impact and Tosen Stardom having shone in the country and indeed Winx's dam Vegas Showgirl (Al Akbar) having been covered by him last year. He will have to recover from a neck injury that has ruled him out of the rest of the northern hemisphere breeding season though.

Mind you, Deep Impact is not the Japanese stallion ranks' only attraction; **Lord Kanaloa** (King Kamehameha) is showing every sign

of becoming an exceptional progenitor, most obviously through his brilliant daughter Almond Eye. Incidentally, a Lord Kanaloa-Winx foal would have inbreeding to an unlikely name in 1969 Epsom Derby (Gr 1, 1m4f) winner Blakeney (Hethersett).

Then of course in Newmarket there is **Frankel** (Galileo), whose handful of runners in Australia has yielded Group 2 winner Miss Fabulass, the Group 1-placed Eminent and Frankely Awesome and stakes performers Farooq, Finche and Merovee.

Frankely Awesome is out of the Street Cry mare Street Secret, and the cross has another exciting representative in Outbox, who is unbeaten in three starts for Simon Crisford.

Wild cards

So obsessed with sprinting and milling and against staying has breeding become that we just assume that the object of Winx's mating is a foal who will excel over no further than middle distances.

But why not harness the mare's ability to stay ten furlongs and send her to a stamina stallion with the aim of producing a horse who could compete from 12 furlongs up to the longer distances of Australia's great cup races?

In that respect, there would be worse calls than **Fiorente** (Monsun), the Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) winner who has acquitted himself well at Sun Stud, his early crops containing an Australian Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) runner-up in Hawkshot and Victoria Derby (Gr 1, 2500m) second in Stars Of Carrum.

Or, while we're roaming the realms of the highly unlikely, how about **Needs Further**, the Tasmanian-based son of Encosta De Lago (Fairy King) whose daughter Mystic Journey became the first filly from the island state to land a Group 1 when she defeated Hawkshot to take the Australian Guineas last month?

We can only guess which stallion Winx's owners will opt for but one thing is for certain: the resultant foal will be the object of inordinate attention at the sales should they be put on the market and then on the track in the coming years.

Azzopardi takes off with Drone

Perth jockey Joseph Azzopardi did not have to wait too long to open his account in Singapore after he scored at his only ride on Friday night, Drone (Golden Archer) in the S\$50,000 Class 4 Division 3 race over 1200 metres.

Beginning his three-month stint last Friday when he finished out of the placings from four rides, who were to be fair not really live hopes, the 23-year-old did not let his solitary booking go begging one week later.

Though posted out widest of all in gate 12, Azzopardi was quick to punch the three-year-old out into a prominent berth, happy to keep race-leader Ladrone (Nicconi) in his sights.

Swinging for home, Drone easily shot past the weakening bunny, and it would have taken a brave person to tip against the West Australian hoop from breaking the ice with 200 metres to go.

Drone (S\$44) had Lim's Knight (Kaphero) as the only challenger who could still thwart him, but he didn't falter, leaving the Daniel Meagher-trained six-year-old chasing shadows, though the margin was whittled down to half-a-length in the end.

Gold Strike (Iffraaj) ran third another two and three quarter lengths away. The winning time was 1:12.42 for the 1200 metres on the Polytrack.

Azzopardi couldn't have been more relieved

that much-needed first winner has come sooner rather than later.

"I was never in doubt once he got across. My only concern was the wide gate," said Azzopardi, who came to Kranji boasting a tally of 380 winners racked up in eight years of riding in Perth.

"Once he could cross, I was very confident, and he worked to the line good. It feels much better now that I've got that first winner out of the way.

"I'm really enjoying my stay in Singapore, and hopefully, it's onwards and upwards from now."

Clements said from the short time Azzopardi had been helping out with trackwork at the yard, thanks to his assistant-trainer Michael White who knew him from his Perth days with Simon Miller, he had already seen some good work ethic.

"Joe has done a pretty good job in Perth. My B-trainer knows him, there was a connection there and from the short time he's been here, he's proven to be a good worker and I think he's got a bright future here," said Clements.

"To be honest, we were a bit disappointed at his first-up run after a good break because he trialed really well.

"Vlad (Duric) came back and said he was looking for six furlongs and he also needed the run. Tonight, Joe rode him a treat.

"He gave him every chance from a wide barrier and they came off some fairly reasonable sectionals. We got him from the Gold Coast breeze-ups, he's pretty smart, but I think the real test will come when he goes up to Class 3 company."

Drone has now recorded three wins, two seconds and one third from ten starts for stakes earnings that have tipped over the S\$120,000 mark for the Falcon Racing No 7 Stable.

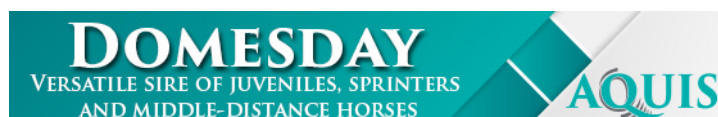
