Record Magic Millions Gold Coast auction lays solid foundation for rivals

Strong start to 2020 Australasian yearling sale series sets high bar for season

agic Millions has set the bar high for the Australasian bloodstock market in 2020 after completing the highest-grossing yearling sale in the southern hemisphere for the third consecutive year.

The auction house can lay claim to the record result after the Book 2 session of the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale ended late yesterday. A total of 128 horses were sold, headlined by a \$370,000 Iffraaj (Zafonic) colt, the highest paid at this sale. Book 2 averaged \$77,906 with an aggregate of \$9.972 million. *Continued on page 2>>*

Standout set to deliver

Heritage Stakes (Listed, 1100m) winner Standout (Exceed And Excel) is set to trial at Rosehill tomorrow with a view to returning to the track in early February. Trained by Gerald Ryan, Standout - who is a brother to the Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Overreach - was last seen running second to Cosmic Force (Deep Field) in the Roman Consul Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) on October 12. "Standout is trialling on Tuesday. I'm very happy with how he's come back," Ryan said. "He will resume in either the Expressway or the three-year-old race the following week. It will be on the first or the eighth of February."

<< Continued from page 1 The question now is: can the demand for horses be maintained through the multitude of sales, starting with the New Zealand Bloodstock Karaka Yearling Sale on Sunday week?

Inglis kicks off its series with the Classic Sale in February, a day after its Inglis Millennium Raceday at Warwick Farm, which will provide further evidence as to whether the overall pie is on the rise or if Magic Millions has increased its market share.

In the lead-up to the sale, both publicly and privately, industry identities - including breeders, vendors, agents and syndicators - expressed the view that this year's Gold Coast Yearling Sale could fall off the 2019 record.

Most suggested it was likely to come back by about five per cent, or remain on par if all went well. A 20 per cent decline was not completely dismissed when the discussion was raised during early inspections.

But like the winning post, the fall of the hammer is the real indicator and the buyers spoke, leading to 709 Book 1 yearlings finding new homes for an aggregate of \$177,407,000, up 4.6 per cent year on year.

The average of \$252,221, which was up from \$239,809 on the 2019 sale, saw an increase of 5.17 per cent, while this metric broke the \$250,000 barrier for the first time. A \$180,000 median was also up \$10,000 year on year.

Respected bloodstock agent John Foote said it was buyers' willingness to spend at the first yearling sale of the year, rather than the quality of the catalogue, that led to an increase.



Glenn Burrows revealed the Iffraaj (Zafonic) colt, along with two other Willow Park Stud-consigned yearlings, had been selected for Book 1. "But I thought they'd be more of a standout today and it certainly showed with the competition on him and the rest in the draft," Burrows said. "It's simply the big fish, small pond strategy. He'd had 13 repository hits, which is a lot for a Book 2, and the interest was so strong it was hard to say where he'd end up. He'd been the most popular horse by number of inspections in the draft for the previous four straight days and that included the Book 1 section." Burrows put an \$80,000 reserve on the colt, who is set to be trained by Kris Lees. "It was a great thrill to not only have the sale topper but we've also topped the averages and we had a decent-sized draft with our nine in today, too," he said. Orbis' Paul King said: "He 's an athletic enough type of horse. We are probably going to take a bit more time with him. I'm not going to rush him as a two-yearold. We'll give him time to develop more as a three-year-old. That breed seems to get better with a bit of age. He is a nice horse who could be a nice Hong Kong horse down the line."

Wayne Hawkes said there was no questioning the racetrack ability of Golden Rose Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) winner and Darley sire Exosphere (Lonhro), whose first crop are two-year-olds. "He was just a really, really nice colt. I was with my father the first time we saw him and we just both thought he was a quality colt, so I wrote 'JRH loves him' across the top of my catalogue," Hawkes said.

<< Continued from page 2 "I don't think the catalogue was any better and there were a lot of first season sires. You would think that would bring it back a little bit, but it doesn't, they buy them anyway," Foote said.

"I think a lot of the trainers and (owners) have targeted this sale more than they have in the past. Everyone targets this sale, but they have even more so this year.

"There were also more syndicates put together, more trainers and groups together."

The figures achieved on the Gold Coast came despite the absence of

several key players, including Shadwell, American Jon Kelly, Damion Flower and Phoenix Thoroughbreds.

"I think you're always worried when you've got four or five big buyers who are not going to be here," Thoroughbred Breeders Australia president and Raheen Stud principal Basil Nolan said yesterday.

"You're worried about the top end of the market, but that end has just got stronger and stronger. It was a great sale.

"Obviously the clearance rate was great and it's just gone from strength to strength." $\,$

Nolan believes interest from overseas investors has spurred the growth of not only the Magic Millions sale but Australian yearling sales in general.

"I think we have become very global," he said.

"We have a lot more Americans here now and racing in Australia with the prize-money levels has gone to another level. People want to be involved in Australian racing."

Saturday's Magic Millions 2YO Classic (RL, 1200m) was won by Away Game (Snitzel), who is raced by a syndicate headed by American Hannah Mathiesen, while runner-up Stellar Pauline (Not A Single Doubt) is owned by US billionaire Barbara Banke's Stonestreet Farm.

Nolan hopes the momentum can continue for the remainder of the sales season.

"Obviously this is the benchmark sale - it sets the benchmark for everyone - and they go on from there," he said. *Continued on page 6>>*

The sale of the Shalaa (Invincible Spirit) colt for a partnership including co-trainers Tony and Calvin McEvoy provided a windfall for agent Dave Mee of Pinhook Bloodstock and his client Roger Sousa of Platinum Racing and Breeding. The pair bought the horse as a weanling at last year's Magic Millions National Weanling Sale for \$75,000. "We saw him when we were doing our inspections of the main book and we loved him," agent Suman Hedge said. "We felt that he should have been in the main book on his physique and the way he presented. We like the stallion and we think he is a great representation of them. "This guy, by the look of him, is quite neat and ready to go. A few of them (Shalaas) look like they will take a bit more time but with him we will give him every opportunity to be a two-year-old." Hedge added that it was identified early that there would be competition for the colt. "That is why we put the team together because we all loved him and we knew that we'd be paying a lot and more if we were going against each other. We put our heads together and thankfully we were able to get him."



<< Continued from page 4 The Hawkes Racing operation of Michael, John and Wayne Hawkes capitalised on their brilliant on-track results in 2019, headed by Doncaster Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Brutal (O'Reilly) and Coolmore Stud Stakes (registered as Ascot Vale Stakes) (Gr 1, 1200m) scorer Exceedance (Exceed And Excel).</p>

In total, the Hawkes' bought 20 yearlings, including a \$1.8 million son of Exceed And Excel (Danehill) for an aggregate spend of \$8.05 million. Among their haul was a \$280,000 Exosphere (Lonhro) colt from the Torryburn Stud draft in Book 2.

The backing of a committed group of clients has allowed the stable to walk away as the leading buyer at the sale, according to Wayne Hawkes.

"Everyone would love to do it, but we had a great year last year with horses like Exceedance and Brutal," Hawkes said.

"If you don't have the clients, you're not going to be here buying the horses. You're only as good as your clients let you be, so we're very thankful we have a great bunch of very loyal clients."

The stable has won multiple Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m), but the co-trainer said plans were already afoot to attack next year's \$2 million Magic Millions 2YO Classic (RL, 1200m) with at least a quartet of their string.

"We were talking about it in the car on the way here today and we definitely have three or four we are going to target at the race next year," he said.

"We have never really targeted the race in the past but we are going to do that this year. $^{\prime\prime}$

Leading Queensland trainer Tony Gollan, who is advised by Foote, bought eight yearlings this week. They ranged from \$110,000 to \$500,000 for a total of \$2.3 million.

Gollan was blunt about the depth of the market.

"I'd rather be a breeder than a buyer," he said.

"It's been a strong sale, but I think we've bought well. We bought well early and it has been held all week.

"It's been tough but we've bought some nice horses and we're happy with what we got."

Agent Suman Hedge said: "From the start, this sale has been incredibly difficult to put values on horses.

"You still have got to have that premise as to how far you are willing to go, but if they are popular and there's people on them, then you have got to be fairly aggressive to be able to buy them."

Tony Gollan is hoping that lightning can strike more than once after buying a colt by Deep Field (Northern Meteor) from Book 2. "John (Foote) selected him and we've had a bit of luck buying on the Sunday," Gollan said. "We bought Ef Troop on the Sunday previously. I'm not saying this horse is like him, but you can find a precocious colt who might be able to make a two-year-old and chase some of that two-year-old bonus money. This horse fits that bill. We will break him in early and see if we can get him up and going."

<< Continued from page 6 The strength of the market showed no signs of slowing down during yesterday's smaller Book 2 catalogue of 177 horses, highlighting how buyers in the low-to-middle bracket, who for the most part were shut out of the four-day Book 1 auction, were keen to get in on the action.

"There was a huge craving for quality horses today, I thought the vendors supported the sale with particularly good types this year," Magic Millions managing director Barry Bowditch said.

"The team has obviously selected the catalogue on type and to have an increase of over \$15,000 on average is an outstanding result in this market.

"To have the amount of horses making above \$100,000 and \$200,000 with a top price of \$370,000 says if you present the right horses in these markets, there is a huge craving for buyers to bid on them."

He added: "Given the fact Book 1 was as strong as it was, plenty of people with expectations to buy in that book didn't buy the amount they wanted or not at all, so they go to the next sale and continue on to try and buy the quality horses, which was evident today."

What potentially augurs well for Inglis, New Zealand Bloodstock and the

remaining Magic Millions auctions is the fact the Hong Kong Jockey Club bought two yearlings on the Gold Coast for a combined \$300,000 despite compiling an extensive list and Yulong Investments' Yuesheng Zhang did not feature on the buyers' sheet.

Orbis Bloodstock's Paul King, who went to \$370,000 to secure the Iffraaj colt from the Willow Park Stud draft, said the organisation planned to be active at the upcoming yearling sales.

"There are plenty of sales coming up and so we have had to limit ourselves to what we want to take now," King said.

"We've got Easter, Premier and the Classic Sale coming up as well."

Orbis Bloodstock signed for four yearlings for a total of 1.04 million on the Gold Coast.

Makybe Racing and Breeding's stud manager Joe Murray said owner Tony Santic decided to reinvest in a yearling after selling all nine lots under the Lime Country Thoroughbreds banner in Book 1. "When she walked out, the one thing I noticed about her was her big deep nostrils. She was a beautiful nice, neat tidy filly. There were a few little blemishes, but we saw more that was right with her than what was wrong with her," Curran said. KBL Thoroughbreds' Kandice Pritchard said the filly stood out in Book 2, while the Aquis Farm stallion initiative also helped create interest for the daughter of first season sire Divine Prophet (Choisir). "She was a really good opportunity to snag a nice filly and, with the bonuses, why wouldn't you? She was definitely a Book 1-quality filly and she was going to get the result in either book, but she was probably a standout in this book," Pritchard said.

Gollan dominates summer carnival

Tony Gollan saddled a double at the Gold Coast on Saturday, with Vega One (Lope De Vega) taking out the Magic Millions Cup (RL, 1400m) Outback Barbie (Spirit Of Boom) landing the Magic Millions QTIS (1300m), to cap a magnificent summer carnival for the Queensland trainer. Since the beginning of the carnival on November 9, Gollan has won 14 metropolitan races, accumulating \$2.2 million in win and place prize-money. In total, his metropolitan earnings for the season lie at just under \$4 million from 55 winners, while his overall stats read 75 winners for \$4.3 million. Gollan said he liked to target the summer carnival each year and earmarked several races for his horses early on. "For instance we won the new races The Gateway and The Wave which we were able to target early on," he said.

Fung plays successful Game with Millions' women's bonus

Aguis Farm's presence in Australian racing and breeding is far-reaching and appears to get bigger by the week, but Loretta Fung's small string of horses she races in her own name have also enjoyed a remarkable run of success. On Saturday, it was two-year-old Away Game (Snitzel), a Ciaron Maher and David Eustace-trained filly, who claimed the \$2 million Magic Millions 2YO Classic (RL, 1200m) for Fung, the wife of Aquis Farm founder Tony. She also shares in the ownership of 2018 winner Sunlight (Zoustar) and Dubious (Not A Single Doubt) who was runner-up in last year's race. All three horses are owned by all-female syndicates. "Mrs Fung loves racing her horses and personally coming here to Magic Millions on the coast," Aguis Farm's Sally Williams said. "When

you looked at her record, you really couldn't imagine a more successful association with the women's bonus."

Doncaster aim for The Candy Man

Barry Baldwin has confirmed popular grey The Candy Man (Casino Prince) is to undertake a spell prior to being set for the Doncaster Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) at Randwick on April 4. The six-year-old ran sixth in Saturday's Magic Millions Trophy (2400m), after which he was found to be suffering from the thumps, but Baldwin felt the combination of 61 kilograms and how the race panned out contributed to the result. "The Candy Man was booked in for a break at a spelling property even before Saturday," Baldwin said. "He has been up for a good while this time, dating back to a Sydney campaign for the Epsom. He can have a break and then we will head to Sydney for the Doncaster Mile."

Drama fails to stop Millions meeting

Gold Coast Turf Club chief executive Steve Lines has expressed his delight with how the GCTC were able to handle Saturday's extraordinary set of circumstances. Firstly, an oil tanker overturned on the M1 connecting Brisbane and the Gold Coast, leaving the highway closed in both directions and forcing several key runners - including subsequent Magic Millions Guineas (RL, 1400m) winner Alligator Blood (All Too Hard) - to arrive under police escort. Racing was delayed to accommodate the late arrivals, while Champagne Cuddles (Not A Single Doubt) - who was retired having sustained an injury in the Magic Millions Snippets (1200m) - required transportation to an equine hospital and officials had to wait for the horse ambulance to return to the track. "We had about 24,000 patrons on course which is the biggest crowd in years. Things ran smoothly for them," Lines said. "I think we managed the racing side dramas well. The police were great to get the runners here and the stewards did the right thing in holding up the races. Hopefully, we will never get the same set of circumstances again but I think we showed we could handle it."

Nowra postponed

Racing NSW stewards were forced to postpone yesterday's meeting at Nowra due to deteriorating air quality as a result of the nearby bushfires and the fixture is now scheduled to take place on Friday. The abandonment came after the air quality was downgraded from poor to hazardous. Racing NSW will release a new programme this morning, with nominations to close at 4pm and acceptances taken at 9am Wednesday.

NEW ZEALAND

Vernazza upstages rivals at Ellerslie

The highly-touted Vernazza (More Than Ready) improved on the form of her debut third at Matamata when running out a long-neck winner of the NZB Insurance Pearl Series Race (1200m) at Ellerslie yesterday. A half-sister to New Zealand 1,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) fourth Bavella (Snitzel), Vernazza is trained by Lance Noble, who said postrace: "She had shown a lot at home and we thought a bit of her but first-up she was probably just a bit new. She had found everything easy at home but on raceday the pressure is on, although it was still a good effort to run third and she learnt a lot from it. Today she still over-raced in the middle stages, so she is a work in progress, but is a filly with a lot of promise. As long as she comes through the race well, we will sit down and make a plan as I think she is just going to keep on improving."

Doubles for Marsh and Waddell

Stephen Marsh and jockey Jason Waddell secured doubles at Ellerslie yesterday. The duo teamed up to land the opening contest with promising three-year-old Run To Perfection (Sepoy), while Marsh registered his second victory on the card when Santa Catarina (Savabeel) bounced back to winning form in the the open 1200-metre contest. Waddell notched his second leg in the Barfoot & Thompson (1500m) with a fine front-running effort on Pimlico (Proisir). "He's a colt we have a lot of time for," Marsh stable representative Todd Pollard said of Run To Perfection. "He's one of the better three-year-olds in the stable. The 1600 metres might be a touch too far for him at present, so sprinting might be the caper for him, but he's a bloody nice horse." Pollard indicated that Run To Perfection would now be set for the Mr Tiz Trophy (Gr 3, 1200m) at Ellerslie on January 25.

Pike on target for carnival



Endless Drama

Tony Pike is set to field a strong hand on the second day of the Trentham carnival this weekend, with Endless Drama (Lope De Vega) scheduled to line up in The Telegraph (Gr 1, 1200m), while New Zealand 1,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Loire (Redoute's Choice) will make her reappearance in the Desert Gold Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m). "Endless Drama had no luck in the Railway on New Year's Day as he got caught three-wide throughout so you can put a line through that run," Pike said. "He has worked up well and we are hoping for a much better draw this time. Loire had a run at the Cambridge trials last Monday and won very comfortably over 1000 metres, so she is forward for her first start back after a nice break in the

paddock. We also have Bostonian nominated for the Telegraph but I will be having a chat with his owner about whether we go or not."

McDonald to ride Conqueror

James McDonald will ride Conqueror (Fastnet Rock) in the Karaka Million 3YO Classic (RL, 1600m) as he and the Lindsay Park stable chase back-to-back wins in the NZ\$1 million contest at Ellerslie. McDonald was in the saddle when Long Leaf (Fastnet Rock) landed the spoils for Lindsay Park last year and recent Caulfield winner Conqueror is following a similar leadup. "He came through the win at Caulfield well and he will head over the week of the race," Lindsay Park co-trainer Tom Dabernig said. "We're trying to follow a similar pattern to what we did with Long Leaf. We didn't have him 100 per cent wound up for that race at Caulfield, thinking in three weeks time we were going to a mile. We did that with the travel and everything in mind. He did a good job to win and there will probably be a bit of improvement to come."

ASIA

147 for Deep Impact

Late Shadai Stallion Station resident Deep Impact (Sunday Silence) sired his 147th stakes winner yesterday when the Kazuo Fujisawatrained Sanctuaire (3 f ex Hilda's Passion by Canadian Frontier) landed the Shinzan Kinen (Gr 3, 1600m) at Kyoto.
