## Mills smells the roses after Daisies sells to Yulong for \$920,000

*Ultra's Buckley buys King Colorado's dam More Aspen for \$720,000 in strong Inglis Digital auction*

**S**heamus Mills is no stranger to buying and selling high-priced horses but he admitted yesterday to being as nervous as he's ever been.

The Victorian bloodstock agent had a hand in the two of the three highest-priced lots of the Inglis Digital June (Late) Online Sale, selling \$920,000 Group 2 winner Daisies (Sebring) and the Group 3 winner Literary Magnate (Written Tycoon) who made \$640,000.

The two rising five-year-old mares were

purchased by Yulong's Zhang Yuesheng, whose quest for breeding stock remains unsatisfied despite a years-long international investment amounting to tens of millions of dollars.

More Aspen (More Than Ready), the dam of this year's JJ Atkins Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) winner King Colorado (Kingman) and who is in foal to Maschino (Encosta De Lago), also sold for \$720,000 to Ultra Thoroughbreds' Sean Buckley, while New Zealand stakes-placed mare Not Guilty (Not A Single Doubt) made \$480,000 to Hunter Valley Bloodstock. *Continued on page 2 >>*

<< *Continued from page 1* A half-sister to ATC Golden Pendant (Gr 2, 1400m) winner Subpoenaed (Rip Van Winkle), Not Guilty is currently back in work at Cambridge with trainer Tony Pike.

Mills, meanwhile, co-owned the Mick Price and Mick Kent Jnr-trained Daisies, a Stocks Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m) winner who also scored twice at Group 3 level, while he purchased Northwood Plume Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) winner Literary Magnate as a yearling for Warrnambool-based trainer Matthew Williams.

He acted as selling agent for the connections of both mares.

"It is a different feeling to selling one through a live auction, I have got to say. It's a much slower burn, so you've got a bit more time to question yourself or get nervous and all of the above," Mills told ANZ Bloodstock News.

"It was a different experience, so I am pretty happy with how it all worked out,"

Daisies, a \$250,000 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale purchase from the Widden Stud draft, earned \$553,000 in prize-money in her 15 starts in which she won three.

She had one start last campaign, at Flemington in March, and has not raced since.

"She has been a great horse to race. I have said that of all the horses I have raced, she is one I would have kept hold of," Mills said.

"I don't think I've raced one more determined than her. A couple of

times, particularly in her wins at Moonee Valley, she put her head in gaps that didn't exist, so she was a really fun horse to race and I think she'll be a brilliant mother.

"She's got more personality than any horse I've owned and I think she'll really look after her foals and if she can put a little bit of her own intestinal fortitude into them, she'll reward them in spades."

Mills was also relieved after Literary Magnate, a \$135,000 Inglis Classic Yearling Sale graduate who won \$520,000 in her 14 career starts, was sold with a significant price tag.

"Matty Williams has been a great supporter of mine and he was one of the first people to use me when I went out on my own and we've had a good bit of success together and, funnily enough, I felt a lot more pressure selling her than I did with Daisies," the Melbourne-based agent said.

"I just really wanted her to sell well for him. He put a good group of owners together [headed by Australian Thoroughbred Bloodstock's Darren Dance]. When I bought her, I remember he had no owners for her and it was a little bit of a stretch of the budget. *Continued on page 3>>*

<< *Continued from page 2* "He got her syndicated ... so it was more relief for her to sell well because I knew all the backstory.

"I was rapt to see her get what I thought was a pretty fair price."

Hours later, in an almost 11-hour online auction, Ultra Thoroughbreds' Buckley purchased More Aspen for the second-highest figure of the late June digital sale.

Western Australian-based owner and breeder Kim Doak, along with Ascot-based trainer Luke Fernie, paid \$42,500 for More Aspen in foal to Pride Of Dubai (Street Cry) in 2021, but following the rapid emergence of King Colorado over the past six weeks, they chose to cash in on the rising value of the mare.

Buckley was thrilled to be able to buy the mare.

"For her to have produced a Group 1 winner so early in her career is an unbelievable achievement so who knows how far she can go as a broodmare," he said.

"We'll foal down the Maschino foal and then decide who we send her to next but there are plenty of options."

Doak had received significant private offers from bloodstock agents to sell More Aspen, so he was delighted with last night's result.

"It's crazy, absolutely crazy, I don't know what to say," Doak said.

"I still can't quite believe what's just happened. You hear about these stories and hope that one day it might be you and today was our day.

# Banning gambling advertising among 31 wagering reform recommendations

Racing will be exempt from a gambling advertising ban, with spruiking and promotion of betting allowed on dedicated channels and programming under a far-reaching federal government committee plan to rein in Australia's \$50 billion dollar wagering sector.

The You Win Some, You Lose More report into the nation's online gambling industry, which has exploded over the past decade, made 31 recommendations including the phasing out of online gambling advertising over a three-year period and the prohibition of corporate bookie sponsorship.

The House Standing Committee on Social Policy and Legal Affairs also recommended that the incentivisation of punters to wager - through the offering of bonus bets and other money back promotions - will also be prohibited "without delay".

While the three codes of racing appear to have been spared from the blanket ban on the \$300 million-a-year gambling advertising market, the recommendations, if implemented, will have lasting implications for the revenue streams of major sporting organisations, such as the Australian Football League and National Rugby League.

Responsible Wagering Australia (RWA) - the peak body representing major corporate bookmakers Sportsbet, Entain's Ladbrokes and Neds, Bet365, Betfair, Unibet and PointsBet - said yesterday that a blanket ban on gambling advertising was a step too far.

"RWA recognises community concerns around online wagering advertising and there are more effective ways of meeting community expectations," RWA chief executive Kai Cantwell said in a statement.

"Other more measured options which could be considered by the government include capping the numbers of gambling ads to be shown.

"By doing this, the expectations of the



community to see less advertising would be met, while also maintaining the crucial support to sporting codes and local broadcasters.

"RWA members, along with broadcasters and major sporting codes have publicly acknowledged that there is a growing desire in the community to see less gambling advertising.

"However, blanket bans - even in a phased roll out - are short sighted, ineffective and are not the answer.

"We know that strict changes - like blanket bans and banning inducements, such as bonus bets - often prove ineffective in addressing problem gambling, with Australians instead turning to illegal offshore markets as they seek out these options."

Unlike the United Kingdom, which is wrestling with the imposition of affordability checks on gamblers, the committee stopped short of recommending such action be enforced on Australian punters.

"While there is evidence suggesting that universal mandatory pre-commitment, with a requirement for individuals to prove they can afford to gamble at higher levels, may offer the best protection for people who are struggling to control their gambling, this may be too much of an imposition for most people who gamble," the cross-party report said.

"Customers should be encouraged to set deposit and bet limits that are safe for them and

be provided with research-informed education and tools to help them bet within their limits. Further work is needed to demonstrate that universal mandatory pre-commitment will, on balance, lead to better outcomes in Australia, noting that the other reforms recommended in this report should substantially reduce online gambling harm."

Labor MP Peta Murphy, who chaired the inquiry, said: "A phased, comprehensive ban on online gambling advertising is recommended within three years.

"This will give major sports and broadcasters time to find alternative advertisers and sponsors, while preventing another generation from experiencing escalating gambling harm.

"The committee has also recommended stronger consumer protections for licensed online gambling, including a requirement for wagering service providers to verify their customers' identity before accepting bets from them, a ban on inducements and a legislated duty of care. We have also called for a crackdown on illegal gambling websites."

Federal communications minister Michelle Rowland said: "The government will now consider the report and its recommendations in full, and in consultation with key stakeholders, before outlining proposed reforms."

### Stokes has Lavish thoughts for stayer

Pakenham-based trainer Phillip Stokes is expecting a further step up in distance to bring out improvement from his stayer Lavish Thinker (So You Think) when the three-year-old tackles the Mahogany Challenge Final (2500m) at Flemington on Saturday. The son of So You Think (High Chaparral) is set to make his eighth career start in this weekend's event and Stokes feels the gelding reminds him slightly of his

former Adelaide Cup (Gr 2, 3200m) hero Good Idea (So You Think). "He's a So You Think and if you look at his profile and compare his profile to a horse like Good Idea that won an Adelaide Cup and other staying races, he's in front of him at the same stage," Stokes said. Lavish Thinker has one win so far in his career and was last seen finishing eighth over 2000 metres in a Flemington handicap. He has drawn widest in gate 16 with in-form jockey Zac Spain booked to ride. "He's drawn [in] the car park, but he's definitely looking for the trip now," Stokes said. "We need a bit of luck but I'm happy with the

## Guineas litmus test for Grebeni

A trio of successive wins in Sydney has prompted trainers Gerald Ryan and Sterling Alexiou to target Grebeni (Ocean Park) at this weekend's Winx Guineas (Gr 3, 1600m) at the Sunshine Coast. The son of Ocean Park (Thorn Park) was narrowly beaten first-up this preparation but a mid-week win at Warwick Farm, combined with successive Saturday-grade victories at Rosehill, means the gelding will now tackle stakes company for the first time. "Just the way he came through that race convinced us to run," Ryan said. "Ryan Maloney is riding him and then he will have a spell up there. He's a horse who doesn't do a lot of work and Kerrin [McEvoy] said that in his opinion, it would be easy to do because he's got a turn of foot and I haven't tried to train that turn of foot out of him. I'd like to see him settle back, wind up and hit the line rather than being up front and being the hunted."

## Emperor set to reign at Rosehill

Murwillumbah-based trainer Matt Dunn is hoping that dual winner Emperor (I Am Invincible) can continue his improvement when the three-year-old lines up in a 1100-metre handicap at Rosehill on Saturday. By star sire I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit) out of the Group 1-placed mare Jolie Bay (Fastnet Rock), Emperor was third behind subsequent Group 2 winner Sejardan (Sebring) on debut in the 2021 Breeders' Plate (Gr 3, 1000m) at Randwick and also finished midfield in Xtravagant Star's (Xtravagant) Inglis Millennium (RL, 1100m)

before being spelled with a view to the spring. However, a barrier trial incident last August put a stop to any plans had. "He fractured his pelvis in a trial at Rosehill and that's why he had so long off," Dunn said. "Then he transferred here [to Murwillumbah] and he seems to enjoy the environment. His head seems to be in a better space than what it probably was in Sydney so he's going to be a nice horse for us in the future. He was good [when] winning his maiden and he was better at Doomben [last start] because he led and got softened up early. They made him work pretty hard, but he was dominant again. He is still a bull and he has just needed time but he's a decent horse going forward for sure."

## Collings to give Mogo Magic Kosciuszko trial

Unbeaten in three starts to date, the Scott Collings-trained Mogo Magic (Duporth) will line up in an 1100-metre event at Rosehill on Saturday with connections eyeing up a crack at the \$2 million The Kosciuszko (1200m) on Everest Day. Mogo Magic was a \$1.85 favourite to land this weekend's contest yesterday, and is also a \$6 chance for The Kosciuszko. "If the horse keeps progressing like he is I think he's definitely a chance of getting in the Kosciuszko," Collings told Racing NSW. "He's one of the early favourites and if he comes out and wins on Saturday he deserves his chance in a race like that later in the year. And if he comes out and wins more than likely his next step will be to the 1200 metres. He'd go into Benchmark grade in the city and that will give us a guide to where we are at with him. Obviously there's a chance he

will get beaten one day but we will try to place him in the right race where he gets the right handicap conditions."

## Big things ahead for Taormina

The Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott-trained Taormina (Written Tycoon) could be headed for some early Spring Carnival targets after she made a winning debut in a 1200-metre maiden handicap at Warwick Farm yesterday. Having placed in all three of her barrier trials prior to yesterday's contest, including a third behind stakes placegetter Sicilian (I Am Invincible) and dual Group scorer Learning To Fly (Justify) at the first official juvenile trials of the season, the daughter of Written Tycoon (Iglesia) made all under Tim Clark to beat Arctic Glamour (Frosted) by three-quarters of a length with a further two and a half lengths back to I Am Famous (I Am Invincible) in third. "She has taken a little bit of time but good to see her put in a strong performance like that and back up the early ability she'd shown," Bott said. "I think we can aim up with her. I do think she's a quality type and capable of getting to a better level. Whether we look to give her another run to condition her over the winter, we'll monitor to see what races are coming up. If not, we may just look to keep her freshened up and look for some of those early spring targets. It comes around pretty quickly." Taormina was a \$450,000 Magic Millions purchase for her trainers and Kestrel Thoroughbreds from Newhaven Park and is the third winner from three foals to race out of the metro-winning Exceed And Excel (Danahill) mare Infra Dig.

## Zouprince off the canvas to score

WIDDEN STUD

Zoustar (Northern Meteor) colt Zouprince showed plenty of battling qualities to produce a rallying effort to break his maiden at the second attempt at Warwick Farm yesterday. Ridden by Reece Jones for Peter and Paul Snowden, the colt had made all before being challenged by fellow Zoustar juvenile Dazzle Legend inside the final 150 metres, but managed to repel that rival to score by a nose. The front pair finished three and a quarter lengths ahead of the third-placed Outakandy (Outreach). "He's an improving type and the more racing he does the more he will work this caper out," Paul Snowden said. "He still does a bit wrong and can get the wanders, but when he was challenged that fighting spirit he does possess kicked in and full credit to Reece, he got the best out of him." A \$220,000 Magic Millions purchase from the Baramul Stud draft for Triple Crown Syndications, Zouprince is the first winner out of the winning Fastnet Rock (Danehill) mare Moonlight Waltz, herself a half-sister to Group winners First Command (Commands) and Oneworld (Danehill Dancer).

## Perfect start for Town Crier

Having scored in a Deagon trial on June 13, the Steven O'Dea and Matthew Hoysted-trained Town Crier (Spirit Of Boom) made a winning start on the racetrack yesterday when landing a 1200-metre maiden plate at Eagle Farm. Ridden by Boris Thornton, the juvenile gelding travelled much the best turning into the home straight before hitting the front with 250 metres to go. Kicking clear, Town Crier then held on well from the fast-finishing Payline (Shooting To Win) to score by three-quarters of a length with a further three lengths back to More Trouble (Charm Spirit) in third place. "Once he

got to the front, he wanted to have a good look around," Hoysted said. "I think he would be better suited one pair back with something to chase. He had a good experience today, and he could go through his grades quickly and is one we have a nice opinion of." A \$160,000 purchase for his trainers and Proven Thoroughbreds from the Emirates Stud draft at last year's Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale, Town Crier is the first foal of the stakes-placed, four-time-winning mare Tell Me (Choisir).

## Emotional victory for grieving Mertens

In what was his first ride since the death of his father Peter, apprentice Beau Mertens registered an emotional success aboard Anahita (Shalaa) at Sandown-Lakeside yesterday. A seven-time Group 1-winning jockey, Peter Mertens died last weekend following a battle with pancreatic cancer and his son, a former champion apprentice, stood down from his riding requirements until yesterday's meeting. Anahita strode to a three-quarter length success in the 1300-metre handicap, beating Cuban Link (Testa Rossa). "I could not begin to thank enough all the support the family has got over the last couple of days," the winning rider said. "It has been very difficult for us all, but as this industry does, they all come together when someone is down. It's so heartwarming to see and I'm sure my family feels the exact same way, getting to see all the memories that dad produced on the racecourse and especially the stories that I've been getting from a lot of people over the past few days."

## Future bright for Crimson Light

Co-trainer Michael Kent Jnr is hoping that Crimson Light (Redwood) can race in some better contests next autumn after the four-year-old mare added a second success to her CV in a 1600-metre Benchmark 70 event at Sandown-Lakeside yesterday. Resuming from a spell in the mile contest, having not raced since finishing fourth in a 2040-metre race at Moonee Valley on March 18, Crimson Light relished the Heavy 8 surface to score a three-quarter length win over Lievore (Epaulette), the first leg of a winning double for jockey Carleen Hefel which

took her two wins clear of rival Celine Gaudray in the Melbourne Apprentices' Premiership title. "I had her really ready," Kent Jnr, who trains in partnership with Mick Price, said. "I had her ready to go in a seven furlong race here a couple of weeks ago, but she drew in. I said to the owners she can win first-up, so they were happy to wait for the mile today. She had handled the wet before and I said you'll only get one good fresh run out of her, so that was the plan and it worked. We've always liked her, but we haven't done the right thing by her having run her at Moonee Valley a number of times. I think she can win a race or two over the winter and then put her away for the autumn, which would be good for her."

## Import Time Quest impresses at Sandown

UK import Time Quest (Time Test) produced an impressive display at Sandown-Lakeside yesterday as he added a second win from three starts since arriving in Australia. Having finished runner-up in two starts back in the UK when trained by David O'Meara, the gelded son of Time Test (Dubawi), who is now trained by Matthew Smith, scored a narrow success in a 1400-metre Newcastle maiden on his debut Down Under before a runner-up effort back over the same course and distance on June 3. Ridden by Blake Shinn for the first time in yesterday's event, Time Quest scorched down the outside of his rivals to easily defeat Flossing (Tavistock) by three and a quarter lengths in a 1600-metre Benchmark 70 contest.

## Coolangatta to be prepared for spring

Having finished a disappointing 11th of 17 runners in last Tuesday's King's Stand Stakes (Gr 1 5f) at Royal Ascot, Coolangatta (Written Tycoon) will return home to be prepared for a spring campaign by her trainers Ciaran Maher and David Eustace. "Unfortunately things didn't go to plan and she wasn't able to race at her best," her part-owner Ozzie Kheir told Racing.com. "We still aren't sure what wasn't right with her. To travel and compete against the best in Europe she needed to be 100 per cent physically and mentally ready. She definitely was not mentally on board as

## McDonald cops ban at Ascot

James McDonald has been suspended for 14 days and fined £400 (approx. AU\$765) for his ride on the fourth-placed Artorius (Flying Artie) in last Saturday's Queen Elizabeth II Platinum Jubilee Stakes (Gr 1, 6f) after was found to have used his whip twice above the permitted level.

## SA's Bain announces training partnership

South Australian dual-code trainer Aaron Bain has announced that his foreman Ned Taylor will join him in a training partnership at the beginning of the new racing season. Taylor has been working with Bain's operation, which also trains harness runners, since late 2021. "[I've] just lodged our application for the start of the new training season to go as a dual-training partnership," Bain told Racing.com. "Ned came from the Ciaran Maher and David Eustace team, spending seven-and-a-bit years there. We wouldn't be where we are without Ned and his grounding that he's had in the sport and it's showing through with the results at the moment. It's been a great partnership so far and [I'm] really looking forward to growing it over the coming years."

## Marston inquiry delayed

Racing NSW stewards yesterday accepted a request from the solicitor representing TV presenter and former jockey, Chynna Marston, and her fiancé, Alex Kean, to adjourn the hearing of charges alleging mistreatment of thoroughbred racehorses issued against the pair until July 10. The hearing had been scheduled to take place yesterday but was deferred.

## Somervell mare aiming to end campaign on high

Hastings-based trainer Lee Somervell has admitted that the relocation of Saturday's Tauranga Classic (Listed, 1400m) to his local track is too good an opportunity to pass up as it presents his mare One Dream One Soul (Ekraar) with an ideal chance to end her campaign in perfect style. Heavy rain forced the abandonment of the Listed event's original slot at Tauranga last weekend and One Dream One Soul, who was co-bred and is part-owned by Somervell's partner Shirin Wood, will aim to grab a first black type win in the 1400-metre race. "We thought about putting her in the Rating 75 race here and that would do her and now they've transferred the Classic. It's a lovely race for her and a good even field without being top class," Somervell said. "There's no travel involved and if we had gone to Tauranga it would have been a night away and she hadn't been right-handed before. She's not totally comfortable on a really heavy track. Having said that, she is very fit and that will carry her a long way. If it's loose, which I think it will be, she will handle that. She's only a lightly framed horse, but she's got a big heart and a big finish."

## Top Brass set to make comeback

Having not been seen in public since finishing 11th in the Lightning Handicap (Listed, 1200m) at Trentham on March 19 last year, Top Brass (Epaulette) is set to make his return to racing at Saturday's Ruakaka meeting where he will tackle a 1200-metre Benchmark 75 event. Now a seven-year-old, the gelded son of Epaulette (Commands) won six of his 16 starts for former trainer Jamie Richards and will now make his debut for locally based trainer Michelle Bradley. "It has been exciting having him in the stable," Bradley said. "He had a wind operation earlier on, so it has been trial and error, but everything has been going well. He went to the trials a couple of weeks ago where he came out and won. He pulled up really well and he copped the ground down there, which was fantastic, and he has come through it nicely."

## Double for Ritchie and Murray

Training partners Shaune Ritchie and Colm Murray enjoyed a winning double on the synthetic surface at Cambridge yesterday. Based locally, the pair landed the opening contest on the nine-race card when Nereus (Savabeel), a brother to dual Group 1 winner Savvy Coup, carried breeder-owner Waikato Stud's silks to a maiden victory over 1550 metres, while, just three races later, stablemate Timing (Darci Brahma) scored in a 1300-metre maiden in the Windsor Park Stud colours. "It is always nice when you are training well-bred horses for the bigger studs," Ritchie said. "It is good branding for us when we have got horses by Savabeel for Waikato Stud and Windsor Park are supporting us. It is nice to have that quality of horse coming through the door, especially with the fillies that they will no doubt breed from in time."

# Pierre Ng makes it five wins in two Hong Kong meetings with Happy Valley double

**B**uoyant after a career-best treble at Sha Tin on Sunday, Pierre Ng maintained his impressive momentum with a double at Happy Valley last night to forge to 40 wins for the season in an excellent debut campaign.

Solidifying his place in the Hong Kong trainers' championship top ten, Ng followed Sunday's three-timer with a pair of narrow wins by Turquoise Alpha (Excelebration) and Turin Mascot (Caravaggio) to extend an accomplished freshman season.

Turquoise Alpha posted his third win for the season, having previously struck at Sha Tin on both the turf and dirt circuits before last night's triumph in the Class 4 Ewo Challenge Trophy Handicap (1650m) under Angus Chung.

Outlining a stable target of 45 wins by the end of the term, Ng said: "Hopefully the stable can keep going until the season ends. It [45 wins] should be manageable."

Headed by Total Power (Dundeel) only strides from the finish line, Turin Mascot prevailed by a nose to give Ng his 39th win of the season.

"I knew he had a chance and he just got there. Hopefully, he will mature next season and he will get more straight forward so he can win by a bigger margin than tonight," said Ng.

Ricky Yiu also enjoyed a brace, featuring Solar Partner (Zoustar) and Splendid Living (Starspangledbanner). Solar Partner made it two wins in a row with success in the second section of the Class 4 Dianthus Handicap (1200m) under Hugh Bowman before Michael Dee dictated terms on Splendid Living to win the Class 3 Chamomile Handicap (1650m).

With tomorrow's Hong Kong International Sale fast approaching, Denfield (Deep Field) confirmed his talent with a swooping victory in the third section of the Class 4 Dianthus Handicap (1200m) for Danny Shum and Vincent Ho.

The gelding topped the 2022 Hong Kong International Sale with a bid of HK\$7.8 million

and had twice finished second before last night's impressive triumph, which Shum believes will set the scene for higher future achievement.

"He's improving, he's more relaxed than before. Earlier this season, he wasn't there - he's still only three. He has a bright future next season. He should handle 1400 metres, even 1600 metres," Shum said.

Ho closed the meeting emphatically with the brilliant win of Wonder Kit (Sooboog) in the Class 3 Violet Handicap (1200m) for Francis Lui. Unbeaten in two Australian starts as Aliboog when trained by Les Kelly, Wonder Kit trailed the leaders from barrier one before exploding clear in the finale.

Peter Ho notched his stable's 14th success of the campaign when Keith Yeung drove Splendid Star (Deep Field) - who was unplaced in 17 previous starts - to victory in the Class 5 Camelia Handicap (1800m). Rated only 11, the gelding was having his 12th start of the season with a best finish of sixth at Sha Tin on April 9.

Ho believes the four-year-old benefited

from a winning 1600-metre trial at Sha Tin on June 13.

"It's unbelievable," Ho said. "Actually, after the trial that he won last month - maybe he learned something from that trial. Today, he had a bit of luck because the pace was fast so he could settle at the back easily and in the back straight he just followed the horse that led him into the race.

"He carried a feather weight [115lb] and he's only four."

Needing two more winners at Class 4 or above to satisfy the trainers' performance criteria of 16 wins for the season, Ho said: "I am so keen to train next season because my interest and my hobby is horses. This is why I never give up. I'm keeping my fingers crossed."

Chung laid the foundations for his brace with a superbly judged front-running ride, allowing the Dennis Yip-trained Yeaboi (Belardo) to clinch the first section of the Class 4 Thistle Handicap (1650m) before Harry Bentley combined with Caspar Fownes to land the first section of the Class 4 Dianthus Handicap (1200m) with Young Life Forever (Exceed And Excel).

# THE JO MCKINNON COLUMN



‘I was hooked and thought I have got to get a job here. Two years later I was riding him trackwork’



**O**n a cold, dark winter morning at Flemington some 20 years ago, I had my first foray into reporting on trackwork.

I was a cadet journalist working on the racing round for the Herald Sun and was sent to fill in for one of the senior writers for the newspaper, Tony Meany.

My only instruction was to try my best to sniff out a story that might be worthy of running in the afternoon edition. Being the off season and with most horses worth writing about enjoying the warmer climes of Queensland competing in the carnival there, it was a tough task for someone as green as me.

I stared through the thick fog and all I could hear was the heavy breathing and hooves of horses as they galloped past me performing their routine workouts, and men huddled in and around a small wooden tower, stopwatches dangling from their necks. Eyes fixed on their horses; they said very little.

I had been told to seek out a bloke by the name of Gary Fennessy who worked as foreman for the Hayes stable and that he should be able to share enough insight for me to craft a story from.

Much to my relief, I found him. His calm and kind demeanour immediately eased my nerves.

"I can remember your first day at the track," recalled Fennessy. "Tony Meany had rung me the night before and said 'there's a young girl coming out, can you be nice to her'. And I said 'I'm always nice'."

From that day on, 'Bim' as he's fondly known around the racing traps, was always a reliable source of information on my reporting missions and in his own steady way taught me so much about racehorses. Back then, women were a novelty in racing and sports media, but never once did he patronise or make me feel unwelcome in the male domain that it was.

This week, Lindsay Park Racing recognised an incredible 55 years of service that Fennessy

has clocked up in the famous thoroughbred empire.

In a tweet they said: "55 years and still going strong...we are so fortunate to have his generational experience and knowledge in our team. Thank you, Bim!"

The milestone came as something of a surprise to the man himself, who said: "I had no idea how long it had been, and they said 'you realise you have clocked up something like 20,000 days' and I said 'oh well, I just keep plugging along'"

Fennessy grew up in Port Melbourne and left school at 14 years of age. As a teenager he liked horses and regularly rode ponies on the beach at Williamstown. It was during that time a racehorse by the name of Fileur, who ran second to Rain Lover in the 1968 Melbourne Cup, sparked his interest in thoroughbreds.

"The first horse I remember was Fileur. He was a big, strong thing and a great weight-for-age horse. I went to the races and saw him, and I was hooked and then I thought I have got to get a job here. Two years later I was riding him trackwork."

At the age of 15 Fennessy started working as a strapper for CS Hayes in his Melbourne stable. He then went across to South Australia and spent 15 years working for the original Lindsay Park operation in the Barossa.

"When Kevin Ryan left his post as foreman in Melbourne, CS said to me 'do you want to go

there and be in charge' and that was it, I was there for the next 40 years."

After two decades he became part of the Hayes family.

"CS was always right but he was a very good boss. He was the sort of fella that would listen to anyone and talk to anyone. He was a very genuine boss - you couldn't get a better one. Everyone liked CS. Mrs Hayes was a wonderful person, she always worried about you and cared about you, they were great people."

During the course of that journey Fennessy came into contact with many great horses

including Jeune, At Talaq, Primacy, Miss Finland and the list goes on. The one horse he remembers most fondly is 1990 Japan Cup winner Better Loosen Up.

"He went to Japan and even though we thought he could win you still only dream of those things and when he won, we were in a state of shock for a while."

Now 72, Fennessy enjoys a quieter life than those heady days and two years ago took up a role with Lindsay Park at Euroa.

"These days I mainly watch trackwork and check them after their work and make sure they are ok."

While he's too humble to say it, it's fair to say that he also plays a huge role behind the scenes guiding and mentoring Ben and JD Hayes. "I get along very well with Ben and JD. They are doing a great job," he said.

"They are very good workers. They have been brought up in private schools, but they are always putting in and cleaning boxes and things like that. They are not scared of work, and they are all down to earth and love their sports."

That strong work ethic has always run in the Hayes family, and there's little doubt that Fennessy has also had a major influence on the development of their successful careers. After all, 55 years of experience is well worth listening to.

# IT'S IN THE BLOOD

Trevor Marshallsea's in-depth pedigree analysis

**Z**oukerette became I Am Invincible's latest black type winner in the Listed Tatts Life Member Stakes (1400m) at Eagle Farm on Saturday, sending her sire further clear in quest of his first treble of titles: earnings, winners and stakes winners.

The rising 19-year-old won his maiden general sires' prize last season, but while taking earnings and winners honours he was just one behind four-time champion Snitzel's 18 in the stakes winners column.

This time around, with only quiet July ahead, he's a comfortable \$3.5 million clear of So You Think in the decisive category, has 181 winners to Zoustar's second-best 170, and is panels ahead on stakes winners, with 22 to Snitzel's 15.

It's striking to see only three sires in double figures for that third category this season - So You Think being third with 11 - compared with seven for the full 2021-22, and nine for the season before.

Those spoils have spread further and wider this season, with a handful of stallions emerging. Frankel sits fourth by stakes winners after gobbling up nine for himself this term, having ranked only 30th in 2021-22 with four.

Seven stallions have eight apiece, mostly usual suspects but with rises up the table this year for Toronado, who had six stakes winners last season, and Capitalist, who's shot from 24th with four to tenth now.

Three more sit just behind with seven: Dundee, from 20th with five stakes winners last term to 12th now, Pride Of Dubai (from 26th with four to 13th), and Russian Revolution, who's impressive early strides have continued in his second season after two stakes winners in his first.

We digress somewhat, off that initial point about a certain Yarraman Park stallion living up to his name.

But in the case of Zoukerette - the two-year-

old who's been racing out of Ciaran Maher and David Eustace's Warwick Farm stable and has now won two from six - there's a strong case to be made that it's a mare who's mostly behind the talent. And that also goes to show why Maher and Suman Hedge Bloodstock parted with \$800,000 to buy her from last year's Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale.

There are just two duplications in Zoukerette's first five generations. One is Danzig, not surprisingly, since his ubiquitous son Danehill is near the bottom, and I Am Invincible-Invincible Spirit-Green Desert flows along the top.

Perhaps of greater importance is the 4x4, via two outstanding daughters, of an Irish mare who deserves all the accolades she can get: Eljazzi. All you need to know is she was so good, she was imported to Australia in 2002 - when she was 21 - time enough for just one last mating, before her passing three years later.

Foaled in Ireland in 1981, and bred by Sonia Rogers of Airlie Stud near Dublin, Eljazzi was by moderate American sire Artaius (Round Table) out of the stakes-placed Border Bounty (Bounteous).

Eljazzi had just four starts for one win before retiring to do her best work.

After her first foal didn't receive a name, her second made a rather large one for herself, becoming a Group 1 winner. Rafha (Kris) took the Prix de Diane at Chantilly, winning also a Group 3 and two Listed races in England.

Rafha went to stud and achieved more rare glory, throwing four stakes winners from 14 runners. They were topped by her representative in Zoukerette's pedigree - Invincible Spirit - with his five black type wins including the Group 1 Haydock Sprint Cup in 2002, and who of course became a super sire of 146 stakes winners, 22 at the apex.

Four foals after him, Rafha threw an entire who managed only a Group 3 placing, but who's become an outstanding progenitor, Kodiak (Danehill), sire of 86 stakes winners including six on the highest rung.

In 1990, a few weeks before Rafha brought her first Group 1 as a broodmare, Eljazzi bore her fourth foal to race in Fayfa. She managed just a Listed placing amongst six starts, but again, would play a role in some storied stud success, this time in Australia.

Imported by Coolmore in-foal to American dual Breeders Cup Mile winner Lure (Danzig), Fayfa threw just one stakes winner amid nine

winner and 13 runners, but it was Zoukerette's second dam, the previously alluded to daughter of Danehill, Hillfa.

Hillfa bore, as her second foal, Walk With Attitude (Hussonet). Retained by Gerry Ryan's Limerick Lane Thoroughbreds, Walk With Attitude won the Listed VRC Desirable Stakes (1400m) in 2012. She was later sold privately to John Muir's Milburn Creek. Zoukerette is her fifth foal to race, and their quality - and that impressive family - have ensured high-priced yearlings.

Her first try with I Am Invincible in 2014 produced the unraced filly Pose, before a cover from Snitzel yielded Spend, a \$1.55m colt at Inglis Easter in 2018, bought by Spendthrift Farm. He wound up Group 3 placed, while his year-younger half-brother Elliot Ness (Written Tycoon), sold for \$675,000 to China Horse Club/Newgate and is a dual winner in Singapore.

Walk With Attitude returned to I Am Invincible to produce Isolyfe, a \$360,000 buy by Mulcaster Bloodstock who's not worked out as well as his younger full sister, with just a maiden win for Chris Waller.

Hedge then paid \$500,000 for Walk With Attitude's 2019 throw Zoukerino (Snitzel). This made him comfortably the sale-topper at the 2021 Gold Coast National Sale, where he'd gone after illness forced him out of Inglis Easter. Hedge believes he'd have fetched closer to the \$800,000 paid for Zoukerette if presented at Riverside.

In any case, Zoukerino became his dam's first stakes winner, in Listed class at Rosehill last August, while Hedge's faith in the breed was also followed up with his joint ownership of his half-sister, Zoukerette.

"She was just a beautiful filly and from a great farm in Milburn Creek, which is very important to me," Hedge tells *It's In The Blood*.

"She also has only a little bit of Danehill in her, which makes her a valuable breeding commodity. And I liked that she's out of a Hussonet mare," he said, referencing one of I Am Invincible's strongest nicks, with 13 winners and three stakes winners from 16 runners.

So far, the duplication of Eljazzi appears to have worked better in Zoukerette than in Isolyfe and Pose. It's perhaps a breeding mystery, but

supports a theory taught to Hedge from his years as trainer John O'Shea's racing manager.

"Sometimes, people are quick to dismiss horses and brand them," Hedge says. "But John always said you've got to do a mating a minimum of two or three times to even consider if it works or not, and never dismiss it off one failure. Sometimes full siblings are chalk and cheese. I've tried to be more forgiving in that area recently."

Of his two half-siblings, Hedge is inclined to feel the younger is the better.

"Both Zoukerino and Zoukerette are extremely well balanced and athletic," he says. "Zoukerino has got this great, flashy colouring, but Zoukerette has a bit more scope and has that gorgeous, aristocratic, I Am Invincible head on her.

"Zoukerino, like Spend, might lack a bit of intestinal fortitude. Zoukerette is the opposite. She lifts when she's challenged. She'll run the same race for you every time, whether she's got the run of the race or she's caught three wide the trip."

Meanwhile, that's still not the end of the Eljazzi story.

After Raffa, her second-highest achiever was Chiang Mai (Sadler's Wells), who won a Group 3 for Aiden O'Brien in 2000 before throwing yet another Group 1 winner in Chinese White (Dalakhani), who took the 2010 Pretty Polly Stakes at the Curragh.

And when imported here in 2002, Eljazzi

was in-foal to Danehill. She bore the filly Al Anood.

Sold as a yearling by Riverslea Farm at Magic Millions 2005 for a hefty \$490,000 to Sheikh Mohammed Bin Khalifa Al Maktoum, Al Anood won twice and was Listed placed for David Hayes before continuing Eljazzi's legacy in style.

Her first three named foals were stakes winners, the third being Pride Of Dubai (Street Cry), the dual Group 1 victor who's now left two top-tier winners himself.

The second, incidentally, was Enaad (High Chaparral), who after taking a Group 2 and Group 3 in South Africa found lasting fame in Mauritius as a dual winner of the island's most prestigious - if perversely named - race, the Maiden Cup, in 2017 and 2018. Fittingly, he was ridden by Australians in those wins, in Steven Arnold and Daniel Stackhouse.

All in all, not a bad legacy for Eljazzi, with such quality thoroughbreds and/or breed-shapers as Invincible Spirit, Kodiak, Pride Of Dubai, Raffa and Chinese White just some of those amongst her more direct brood, and others such as I Am Invincible and Kingman (Invincible Spirit) plus their offspring, and Dubai Honour (Pride Of Dubai) warranting mention.

Zoukerette has some potent bloodlines behind her, and some hard acts to follow. At least her first steps have sparked strong hopes that she can live up to the model cast by her glorious fourth dam.
