'How do you beat this?'

Patterson and Grylls combine for feature-race double at Trentham headed by Puntura's win in the Thorndon Mile

There were joyous scenes at Trentham yesterday for trainer Robbie Patterson and jockey Craig Grylls as they enjoyed a stakes double when they saddled the winners of both the Thorndon Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) and Wellington Cup (Gr 3, 3200m).

Puntura (Vespa), who was running in elite company for the first time in his now 33-start career, confirmed himself as one of the most progressive horses in New Zealand as he powered to success in the day's feature.

Having landed both the Coupland's Bakeries Mile (Gr 3, 1600m) and Manawatu Challenge Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) under Craig Grylls on his

previous two outings, the six-year-old gelding was sent off a \$5.50 chance for yesterday's Thorndon Mile.

Taking on rivals such as last-start Zabeel Classic (Gr 1, 2050m) winner Campionessa (Contributer), Rich Hill Mile (Gr 2, 1600m) scorer Habana (Zoustar) and four-time stakes winner Skyman (Mukhadram), Puntura was kept handy in second place by Grylls after jumping nicely from barrier seven.

Travelling effortlessly well rounding the home bend, Grylls wasted no time in sending Puntura to the lead and the gelding dug deep down the long home straight to fend off the persistent challenges of El Vencedor (Shocking) and Lady Telena (Vespa), beating those rivals by one and a quarter lengths and one and three-quarter lengths respectively. *Cont. on page 2 >>*

“This is just the best,” Grylls said. “Over the last couple of years I’ve struck up a really good partnership with Robbie Patterson on the track, and we’re awesome mates off it as well. That was just an outstanding result.

“Right from the jump, he was hard on the bridle. Coming up to the turn, I thought I should try to get out wide before everyone else did. He had a really good kick in the straight, and I knew from about 150 metres out that it was going to take something pretty good to pass him.

“He’s built up to this. He’s been good in Australia, and then he’s come back and won a Group 3, a Group 2 and now a Group 1.

“He’s a gentle giant. He’s a big and strong horse, but an absolute gentleman to ride.”

From his 33 starts, Puntura has now recorded 11 wins and four placings, earning over \$705,000 for his owner-breeders John and Carole and Lynskey.

“This is massive,” Patterson, who also saddled the fourth-placed runner One Bold Cat (The Bold One), said.

“The Lynskeys put a lot into racing, and this is a very good horse. People might have doubted him early on, but now he’s won a Group 3, a Group 2 and a Group 1 in succession.

“He’s a beautiful animal and he deserves it. He’s a big, strong horse, a dominant horse, and he dominated that race today.

“Winning the Thorndon Mile is special. It’s something you dream about as a kid. It means a lot.”

The best foal to come out of the winning Magic Of Sydney (Danehill) mare Mumzahoney, Puntura (6 g ex Mumzahoney by Magic Of Sydney) is a brother to winner Margherita Veloce and a half-brother to two other winners.

Yesterday’s victory for Puntura also provided his sire Vespa (Elusive City) with a first elite-level winner from 89 starters.

Tough Mary Louise caps red-letter day for Patterson and Grylls

A game effort from Mary Louise (The Bold One) in yesterday’s Wellington Cup (Gr 3, 3200m) had trainer Robbie Patterson and jockey Craig Grylls on ‘cloud nine’ as she stayed on best of all to land yesterday’s feature for stayers.

Coming just half-an-hour after the trainer/jockey partnership had revelled in Thorndon Mile glory with Puntura, the five-year-old daughter of The Bold One (Fastnet Rock) provided them with yet another victory to remember.

Lining up as a \$6.50 chance, having ran fourth and third respectively in the Waikato Cup (Gr 3, 2400m) and Queen Elizabeth II Cup (Gr 3, 2400m) on her last two starts, Mary Louise was kept three-wide in the middle of the 16-runner pack by Grylls after jumping from gate nine.

Sent for home under strong riding arriving into the home straight, Mary Louise found plenty for pressure and fought off the late run of Fierce Flight (Flying Artie) to score by one and *Continued on page 3>>*

<< *Continued from page 2* a quarter lengths with the same distance further back to the third-placed Canheroc (El Roca).

Race favourite Waisake (Zed), who was bidding to land a second Wellington Cup, dramatically lost his rider Matt Cameron early in the race after appearing to clip heels when racing in tight space towards the rear of the field.

"Ten years ago, I won both races on the same day with A Touch Of Ruby [in the Thorndon Mile] and Graphic [in the Wellington Cup] which was back in 2014," Grylls said.

"This is the best and to do it for Robbie and Eddie Bourke [part-owner] is outstanding as they are such great people.

"The last few starts she had tailed off and I couldn't get her to go whereas today she actually pulled for the first half of the race and I had a job to settle her.

"I was on the outer and had cover and when I gave her a click she came up underneath me and I knew I was travelling pretty sweet."

Racing in the colours of her co-breeder and part-owner Eddie Bourke, Mary Louise took her career numbers to seven wins and a further three placings from 15 starts yesterday, with over \$325,000 in prize-money earned.

"I'm very emotional to win this as it means a lot to me and is very special," an overwhelmed Patterson said.

"This is a very iconic race and while we in the Taranaki may not always have the best bred horses, we really punch above our weight and I'm very proud of that.

"She [Mary Louise] over-raced a bit early on as she is used to going a bit quicker, but then she found her rhythm.

"She was three, four and even five wide at times so it was a pretty good effort although she stays longer than a mother-in-law. How do you beat this [winning a Group 1 as well as the Cup], well you can't and I'm so proud."

Out of the winning Catbird (Danehill) mare Daisy Louise, Mary Louise (5 m ex Daisy Louise by Catbird) is a half-sister to fellow winners Grant (Redwood) and Eddie Wood (Redwood).

Yesterday's success provided her sire The Bold One with a third individual stakes winner from 56 starters. He stood the 2023 breeding season at Grangewilliam Stud for a fee of NZ\$4,000 (plus GST).

The race also marked the final call for iconic commentator Tony Lee who is hanging up the binoculars after a 40-year career.

Almanzor filly proves too strong in Desert Stakes

Cambridge Stud's shuttle stallion Almanzor (Wootton Bassett) was handed his 12th individual stakes winner, and fourth in New Zealand, when Sudbina produced a strong finishing effort to land yesterday's Desert Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m) at Trentham.

The three-year-old filly was racing for the just the third time at Group level, having run a commendable sixth in the Soliloquy Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) and fourth in the Bonecrusher Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m), following a stylish last-start victory in a 1400-metre event at Hastings on January 6.

Drawn out wide in gate 12 for yesterday's Group 3 contest under Kozzi Asano, Sudbina was eased back to last place by her rider off what seemed a strong early gallop.

Moving into the final 600 metres of the race, Asano asked his mount for maximum effort and Sudbina produced a decisive turn of foot to propel herself to front of the 14-runner field, eventually staying on strongly to deny the persistent Grail Seeker (Iffraaj), who was sent off the \$3.50 favourite, by three-quarters of a length.

<< *Continued from page 3* There was a further three and three-quarter lengths back to the third-placed The Entertainer (Staphanos) as the front pair pulled well clear.

For Sudbina's trainers, Roger James and Robert Wellwood, it put behind them a frustrating day of near-misses on the opening day of the carnival last weekend, having had Zabmanzor (Almanzor) run second in the Levin Classic (Gr 1, 1600m), a head behind Quintessa (Shamus Award), while stablemate Apostrophe (Tavistock) was also beaten a head by Churchillian (Churchill) in the Anniversary Handicap (Gr 3, 1600m).

"After having to settle for a couple of close seconds in Group 1 and Group 3 races last week, it's really nice to get a good win today," Wellwood said.

"We were disappointed when the draws came out for this race earlier in the week, but the way the track has worked out and the way this race ended up being run, it probably worked in our favour a little bit.

"What she did there was very nice. We've been scratching our heads a little bit in terms of what distance might suit her best.

"We were just hoping she'd get the mile in this race, but off today's performance, perhaps she might go even further. We'll talk to her connections and work out a plan from here."

Now with three wins and a placing from seven starts for her owner-breeders Frantic Bloodstock and Haunui Bloodstock, Sudbina is likely to next head for the David & Karyn Ellis Fillies' Classic (Gr 2, 2000m) at Te Rapa on February 10, with the race being the eighth leg of this season's edition of the New Zealand Bloodstock Filly of the Year Series.

Sudbina has now joined the table with her first six points of the series following yesterday's win, moving her into equal-sixth place alongside Quintessa. Molly Bloom (Ace High) heads the table with 20 points, with Impendabelle (Impending) second on 15 and Still Bangon (Satono Aladdin) in third with ten.

"She had an electric turn of foot," Asano said. "I thought I might have gone too early. I just tried to keep her in her rhythm for most of the race today, and then off she went. Once she got a clear run, she was away.

"The way she accelerated at the end of the race today, I'd say that more distance would be no problem for her."

Being out of the unraced mare Destined, in what was yet another broodmare stakes success on the day for Danehill (Danzig), Sudbina (3 f ex Destined by Danehill) is a half-sister to Fix (Iffraaj), who was crowned New Zealand Bloodstock Filly of the Year in the 2012-13 season and won eight races including the Eight Carat Classic (Gr 2, 1600m), Royal Stakes (Gr 2, 2000m) and Sir Tristram Fillies' Classic (Gr 2, 2000m), while also placing in the New Zealand Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) and New Zealand 1,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m).

Almanzor, who will stand at Haras d'Etream for the 2024 northern hemisphere breeding season, stood the 2023 season at Cambridge Stud for a fee of NZ\$50,000 (plus GST).

His other New Zealand-based stakes winners are Zabmanzor, Cheval D'Or, and Dynastic. He has had 327 starters.

Drought over for Bermadez

Michael Moroney's veteran galloper Bermadez (Tavistock) snapped a long losing streak yesterday when he narrowly landed a Benchmark 100 (1600m) at Flemington. Bermadez, who started a \$2.10 favourite, had punters nervous, leaving it until the final strides to hit the front and eventually beat Beehunter (Toronado) by a head. In a post race interview, Moroney told Racing.com. "He's done that before. He tends to arrive late, he doesn't win by big margins. I was quietly confident he would pick them up." Moroney mentioned that he would look to run the gelding over 2000 metres, as he finished the race in the manner of a horse looking for more distance. "I'd like to have another go at 2000 metres with him. We had a go before in the Ballarat Cup when it was very wet and it was also at the end of a long preparation. This is the right time of this preparation to have another go. Also, I think 2000 metres will be his right trip," Moroney said.

Jungle Jim brings up double for Moroney

Later on in the afternoon at Flemington, Jungle Jim (Canford Cliffs) handed Mike Moroney with a raceday double when he landed the Benchmark 84 (1200m). Ridden by Tatum Bull, the gelding came into the race off the back of

victory over the same course and distance and he followed up that win when he easily defeated Rey Magnerio (Magnus) by two and a quarter lengths. Stable representative Glen Thompson said Jungle Jim had pulled up well from his win the previous Saturday, which made them consider backing him up. "Michael [Moroney] and Anthony [Feroce] had a look at the program to see what was around and couldn't see a lot of options other than to step up to stakes grade, so they elected to come here after he came through the run well enough," Thompson told Racing.com.

Aramco dominates at Flemington

The Mick Price and Michael Kent Jnr-trained Aramco (Sea The Moon) has relished a step up in distance to secure his first metropolitan success when he defeated Lauding (Proisir) by two and a quarter lengths in a Benchmark 70 (2000m) at Flemington yesterday. Saturday's victory was Aramco's third and the gelding was coming off a last start fourth over 1800 metres at Flemington on New Year's Day. "Last start they almost went too slow," Kent Jnr said. "He's six months behind the other horses, being a European-bred horse, and he's still open to a lot of improvement." Due to his size, and immaturity, Aramco has spent the majority of his time down at Price and Kent

Jnr's Warrnambool base. "That environment has been so important to his success," Kent Jnr continued. "He's a big horse. He was no good as a colt, so we had to geld him and give him time and we're very thankful to the owner for being patient. I think being down in that country beach environment, it's been good as he was a bit soft boned in the early days, so we've given him the time. That was nice to see at his first try at 2000 metres today and if he could get a mile-and-a-half, it would open up some doors for him."

Options aplenty for One Last Kiss

One Last Kiss (Toronado) has a number of options in the upcoming weeks, after the Dan O'Sullivan trained mare saluted impressively to beat Oceanic Flash (Sacred Falls) by a length and a quarter in a Benchmark 78 (2520m) at Flemington yesterday. In a post race interview, O'Sullivan told Racing.com. "Whether we go to the Torney Cup at The Valley or the Pakenham Cup; or she could even head to the Adelaide Cup, as her owners are from there, and that could be the end goal. She's got a city win up and now the step is to chase black type. If she didn't win today, she was going to Adelaide next Saturday and now she doesn't have to." The mare is bred and co-owned by David Peacock, who also owns the stable's star, Berkeley Square (Territories).

Second win for Power Ballard

The Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott-trained Power Ballard (Exceed And Excel) registered her second career victory when she took out a Benchmark 78 (1100m) at Flemington yesterday. The filly defeated Stefi Magnetica (All Too Hard) by a length three-quarters, while Patchouli Dream (Puissance De Lune) was a further three-quarters of a length away in third. Power Ballard is the first foal out of Right Chord, an unraced sister of five-time Group 1 winner and now Coolmore-based sire Pierro (Lonhro). Right Chord was a \$1,050,000 purchase for James Harron Bloodstock when carrying Power Ballard at the 2020 Magic Millions National Broodmare Sale. "I was on her in her jump-out, and she really impressed me," Jye McNeil said. "It was Gai's idea to head to the rail - coming down from Sydney gave her something to follow. It felt like she was never going to get beaten. She went through her gears nicely and was strong at the finish.

Laing breaks Flemington drought

In winning a Benchmark 70 (1600m) at Flemington yesterday, El Soleado (Toronado) became Robbie Laing's first winner at the Victorian venue since 2019. The gelding came out on top of a close finish to beat Botany (American Pharoah) by a head, while Podente (Redente) was a further length away in third. Laing came back to training in 2022 after having his licence rescinded by Racing Victoria stewards for two years for being bankrupt. Laing thanked El

Soleado's owners Kevin and Colleen Bamford for giving him the opportunity to train him. "They took him out of the SuperVobis Gold sale because he was injured and he had 12 months out. They gave him to me after six weeks in work. He was my only horse in work. I told them he's a good horse in the making." The victory completed a Flemington treble for Swettenham Stud resident Toronado (High Chaparral), following on from the victories for One Last Kiss and Southern Fire.

First winner for Michel

French rider Mickaëlle Michel claimed her first Australian victory yesterday, when she steered Southern Fire (Toronado) to an upset win over 1200 metres at Flemington. The mare came out on top of a blanket finish to beat Shaime (Turffontein) by a nose. Of the win Michel told Racing.com "That was my wish, but a wish and what happens can be very different. It's the next step for me, riding winners at the biggest tracks all over the world. I've only been here for one week, so I can't imagine it better." Michel plans on staying in Australia for the next six months, but having greatly enjoyed her time so far, she is considering extending it.

Guadray registers double at HQ

Consistent gelding So Risque (So You Think) overcame interference to score his seventh career victory, giving Celine Guadray a double at Flemington on Saturday. The Lindsay Park-trained six-year-old stayed on strong to beat He's Our Bonneval (Siyouni) by a head. Helix (Flying Artie) was a further length away

in third. "It was quite a messy race around the corner there," Guadray told Racing.com. "He bounced out really well with the winkers on, he was travelling nicely on the bridle. But then the pace just came out of the race all of a sudden, as he wanted to get charging." Guadray's other winner came on board the Mark Walker and Sam Berguson-trained Sans Doute (Not A Single Doubt) in a Benchmark 78 (1100m).

Skew Wiff and Imperatriz impress at Cranbourne

Friday night's Cranbourne meeting saw an exhibition gallop from two runners from the Mark Walker and Sam Berguson stable, superstar sprinter Imperatriz (I Am Invincible) and Skew Wiff (Savabeel). Both mares had successful spring campaigns in Victoria, with Imperatriz claiming three Group 1s, while Skew Wiff claimed her first Group 1 in the Tarzino Trophy (Gr 1, 1400m). "Both were spot-on, obviously haven't seen the sectionals yet, but they both looked to corner well, change their lead legs and do everything right," Ben Gleeson, head of Te Akau's Cranbourne operation, told Racing.com. "Once they came back in they wouldn't have blown for too long, so just shows their fitness is progressing the right way. We couldn't be happier with that piece of work from both of them. She'll [Imperatriz] go to the Lightning first-up on the 17th of February, so not long now. She'll have five weeks between first and second-up, so plenty of time to improve and freshen up. Then up to Sydney for the long-awaited TJ Smith, where she'll be on the other leg - there's been a lot of speculation in the media, but we can't wait to get up there." Of Skew Wiff, Gleeson said: "She's absolutely flying ..." Gleeson said. "We're tossing up the Oakleigh Plate, so she'll probably head there, and then the Newmarket is an option for her after that."

Red Fox's Fully Lit breaks his maiden

Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott continued their juvenile domination yesterday when Fully Lit (Hellbent) made a winning debut over 1100 metres at Rosehill yesterday. Having finished second in two barrier trials, the colt pulled easily clear in the final stages, eventually beating King Of Roseau (Capitalist) by two-and-a-quarter lengths. Tartaglia (Too Darn Hot) was another half a length away in third. Purchased by owner Redfox Racing for \$60,000 from the Glenlogan Park draft at the Inglis Classic Yearling Sale last year, Fully Lit is out of dual-winning Snitzel (Redoute's Choice) mare Sunlit, making him a half-brother to his Group 3-winning stablemate, The Novelist (Written By). Sunlit's North Pacific (Brazen Beau) filly will be offered by Glenlogan at this year's Inglis Classic sale and she is catalogued as Lot 750.

Inglis Millennium next for Fully Lit

Co-trainer Adrian Bott said Fully Lit would now be aimed at the Inglis Millennium (RL, 1200m) at Randwick on February 10. "He's looked very sharp and was nice and forward for today," said Adrian Bott. "He's shown plenty of potential so it's good to see that level of ability stack up on race day. He's a nice type that will keep improving and being an Inglis sold horse we'll look towards the Inglis Millennium with him."

Caballus impresses nervous Baker

Bjorn Baker admitted to feeling a few pre-race nerves before new recruit Caballus (I Am Invincible) backed up his barrier trial performances with a promising win over 1100 metres at Rosehill. A \$1 million yearling who was formerly raced by an ownership group that

included Coolmore, but he didn't measure up to expectations last spring and was subsequently sold online where he was snapped up by syndicators Darby Racing for \$315,000. Ridden patiently by Josh Parr, Caballus tracked into the race coming to the corner before unleashing down the outside for a dominant length and a quarter win over Wallenda (Trapeze Artist) with another two lengths back to Soldier Of Rome (Snitzel). "It's always a bit nerve-wracking," Baker said. "He has come with a bit of a profile, and I thought he was going pretty well. It was a good win and a nice ride by Josh. We are lucky to get such a ready-made horse."

Sneaky Paige ends losing run with narrow win

The wet weather in Sydney forced Brad Widdup to change his plans with Sneaky Paige (Deep Field) and that decision paid off yesterday when the five-year-old landed a Benchmark 88 (1200m) at Rosehill, beating Meritable (Snitzel) by a nose. "We actually [tried to] book her in to get dynamic scoped and we couldn't get her scoped," Widdup said. "So when the rain came, I said to the owners, 'there is a race here, she is fit and well so we might as well race her'. It's incredible how it turns out."

Trip north pays off for Commanding Artist

Gerald Ryan and Sterling Alexiou's decision to send Commanding Artist (Trapeze Artist) north for a 1200-metre contest at Eagle Farm proved inspired as the colt easily broke his maiden at the Queensland track yesterday. Retained by the Vieira family, who also raced his sire, Trapeze Artist (Snitzel), the two-year-old colt defeated Dream Smart (Smart Missile) by a quarter of a length. Enterprise Defence (Divine Prophet) finished two-and-a-half lengths away in third. Out of the winning Commands (Danehill) mare Love Commands, Commanding Artist is therefore a half-brother to Group 3 scorer Sky Command (Deep Field). "He is a big horse and will be better over more ground - 1400 metres to 1600 metres later on," Ryan said. "We had him in Sydney, but he drew barrier 17, so we brought him up here. I said to Bert (Vieira) it's a bit of practice to see how he cops a trip away. He is immature in the brain.

His [half] sister, Sky Command, by Deep Field, was very fast, but this fellow will be better as he gets older and over more ground. I might give him a break and prepare him for Winter up here with those 1400 metres and 1600 metres races."

First for Vespa

Mapperley Stud resident Vespa (Elusive City) was handed his first elite-level winner yesterday when Puntura (6 g ex Mumzahoney by Magic Of Sydney) landed the Thorndon Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) at Trentham. The best foal to come out of the winning Magic Of Sydney (Danehill) mare Mumzahoney, Puntura (6 g ex Mumzahoney by Magic Of Sydney) is a brother to winner Margherita Veloce and a half-brother to fellow winners Four Degrees (Shocking) and Whoztheboss (Haradasun).

12 for Almanzor

Sudbina (3 f ex Destined by Danehill) became the 12th individual stakes winner, and fourth in New Zealand, from 327 starters for Cambridge Stud shuttler Almanzor (Wootton Bassett) when scoring in the Desert Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m) at Trentham yesterday. Out of the unraced Danehill (Danzig) mare Destined, Sudbina is a half-sister to Fix (Iffraaj), who was crowned New Zealand Bloodstock Filly of the Year in the 2012-13 season and won eight races including the Eight Carat Classic (Gr 2, 1600m), Royal Stakes (Gr 2, 2000m) and Sir Tristram Fillies' Classic (Gr 2, 2000m), while also placing in the New Zealand Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) and New Zealand 1,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m). Almanzor, who stands the northern hemisphere breeding seasons at Haras d'Etream, stood the 2023 breeding season for a fee of NZ\$50,000 (plus GST).

Grangewilliam Stud stallion The Bold One (Fastnet Rock) registered his third individual stakes winner from 56 starters yesterday when Mary Louise (5 m ex Daisy Louise by Catbird) landed the Wellington Cup (Gr 3, 3200m) at Trentham. Out of the winning Catbird (Danehill) mare Daisy Louise, Mary Louise is a half-sister to fellow winners Grant (Redwood) and Eddie Wood (Redwood). The Bold One stood the 2023 breeding season for a fee of NZ\$4,000 (plus GST).

First for Mongolian Falcon

Aberlour (3 f ex Sophie Louise by Postponed) provided her sire Mongolian Falcon (Fastnet Rock) with a first individual stakes winner when winning yesterday's Gore Guineas (Listed, 1335m). Sent off the \$3.25 favourite under Jasmine Fawcett, the Kelvin Tyler-trained filly

surrendered the lead with 200 metres left to run but rallied gamely to deny Hakadecree (War Decree) by a half-length at the line. Epee Beel (Epaulette) finished a further two lengths behind the front two. Out of the winning Postponed (Summer Squall) mare Sophie Louise, Aberlour is a half-sister to the Group 2-placed winner Tobilicious (Natural Destiny). Mongolian Falcon stood the 2023 breeding season at Hauora Farm for a fee of NZ\$3,000 (plus GST).

Trip to Invercargill likely for Aberlour

Promising filly Aberlour is likely to head for the Southland Guineas (Listed, 1600m) at Invercargill on February 17 after her rousing success in yesterday's Gore's equivalent. "We will most likely miss Wingatui [Dunedin Guineas] and go to Invercargill [Southland Guineas]," Tyler said. "After that there is a good race at Dunedin [NZB Airfreight Stakes] and we may look to step her up over further later in the autumn. I guess the only downside is that we lost her dam when she was foaling last year, but we have her and a lovely Satono Aladdin filly to carry on the family so it's not all bad news."



SGP: Winning return to Kranji for Curatolo

Jockey Ryan Curatolo steered Commander Jones (Charm Spirit) to victory in a 1400-metre Class 5 race at Kranji yesterday, in what was his first comeback ride in the jurisdiction. Previously based in Dubai, Curatolo last rode

in Singapore six years ago, but he has stuck to the "tradition" of winning on the first meetings at all his three visits here. The well-travelled French rider landed a double on Golden Spark (Munnings) and Eden Garden (Thorn Park) at his first one-day visit to Singapore on September 1, 2017, before returning for a longer riding term in 2018, when he scored aboard Yaya Papaya (Nadeem) on the New Year Day's meeting. To grace the Kranji winner's enclosure for the 36th time was what Curatolo had been looking forward to since he boarded the plane back on Tuesday night. "It's nice to be back, and a winner on my first ride too," Curatolo said. "Good to have my wife here too. She couldn't the last time as she had work, but she was with me when I last rode here." The Tan Kah Soon-trained Commander Jones scored a half-length win over Smoke And Mirrors (Ocean Park) with China Pearl (Ardrossan) another two and a half lengths away in third.

Vale David Benjamin

The New Zealand breeding industry lost one of its best marketers as well as a genuine character with the passing of David Benjamin on Friday. Benjamin had been battling illness for some time.

Buzz Williams went to school with Benjamin and paid tribute to him: "I was a couple of years ahead of David at Wanganui Collegiate. Two years was a big gap at that age but we did talk horses from time to time and later David came to stay with us at Te Parae. He was very keen. He was very intelligent and studied a lot."

"When Te Parae were negotiating to buy Imperialist, I went to the USA and met with David while there. That was before he went to Blandford Lodge," said Williams.

Journalist and editor John Richardson knew David Benjamin in England: "I knew David well for half a century, as he had worked in Newmarket where we shared a number of close friends including Philip Mitchell, later Director of the National Stud. David had international experience at Claiborne Farm where he met his lovely wife Masey."

"When I first came to New Zealand in 1974 David was back in New Zealand managing Blandford Lodge in Matamata for Sir Jack Butland, and among his stallions was the good sire Shifnal. He then moved on to Field House Stud," said Richardson. "It was not long before David branched out on his own account at Fayette Park near to Tirau, which quickly became a major player in the industry."

Benjamin was the first to recognise the impact and prepotency of Sir Tristram (Sir Ivor) when he syndicated Grosvenor, a winner of the VRC Sires' Produce Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at two. At three, Grosvenor added the Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) and the Victoria Derby (Gr 1, 2500m). At stud he sired 54 stakes winners including 16 at the elite level.

Stallion manager Ray Knight was at Fieldhouse Stud before Grosvenor had runners

and can attest to the fact that Benjamin was a first class marketer. "David knew everybody, all the right people. He knew their families, even their kids' names. He had an amazing recollection," said Knight.

"He was ahead of his time regarding marketing and was the first to set up a marquee at Trentham, originally to feed his staff but which expanded to feeding potential buyers. The hospitality sites at Karaka owe their existence to David who saw the benefits of winning and dining buyers," said Knight.

During the late 1980s the Benjamins established Fayette Park Stud, Tirau. Buzz Williams takes up the story: "David was perhaps the best designer of studs ever. He had a great understanding of what looks good and Fayette Park was brilliantly designed. The house was perfectly placed. You could see the entire operation from there and the planting of the hundreds of trees was magnificent. The stud was truly a showpiece."

Ill health saw Fayette Park sold in 2004 to Gary Harding but not before the stud enjoyed

success with stallions Stark South (Dixieland Band), Prized (Kris S), Don Eduardo (Zabeel) and Postponed (Summer Squall).

Next to Grosvenor, Prized sired 37 stakes winners in the USA and New Zealand. Stark South sired Group 1 winners Hail and Bodie.

Postponed sired the dual Group 1 winner Dorabella, bred by Peter Izett. "I was immediately impressed with Postponed's bloodlines. When I saw Storm Bird, Secretariat, Mr Prospector and Northern Dancer close up in his pedigree I was in like Flynn," said Izett.

Don Eduardo, best known as the colt that made \$3.6 million as a Karaka yearling, sired dual Group 1 winner Booming.

Buzz Williams echoed some of Ray Knight's thoughts regarding Benjamin's innovative marketing but added that appearance was another interesting trait.

"David was bold regarding his dress and drew quite a lot of attention with his American garb. At one sale, David was wearing a garish pair of pants. One leg was black tartan and the other leg was green tartan," said Williams.

Gerald Fell, another lifetime friend of Benjamin's added: "David Benjamin was a great personality in the industry. Flamboyant and hospitable, he was a great marketer and host. He pioneered marquee hospitality at the yearling sales all while wearing his multi coloured trousers which were his trademark."

"David developed Fayette Park Stud between Matamata and Tirau from a farm with no facilities into a world class thoroughbred property. He had a flair for developing subsequent properties. He also purchased and syndicated Grosvenor for stud duties at Fieldhouse, beating off serious opposition from several major studs," said Fell.

The Benjamins downsized and re-established a New Fayette Park Stud in Cambridge, focussed on stallions, but health issues meant that the new property was also put up for sale not long after and the last of their breeding stock was sold in 2005.

In Benjamin's retirement years he could be found, using his wide industry knowledge,

helping out and promoting Pencarrow Stud's drafts at Karaka.

Pencarrow's Leon Casey commented: "David had such a wide knowledge and we were glad to have him on board even if it was on a casual basis. He helped with the foal watch and attended a number of sales with us. He enjoyed being around the horses and people without

the stress of running a stud. You could sense he was more relaxed once he was retired."

Buzz Williams has the last say: "David was a dear friend and I will miss him greatly. He taught many people and his innovative ideas live on. A key to his success was his wife Masey who was a clever woman. She may have been behind the scenes but she was a huge help to him."

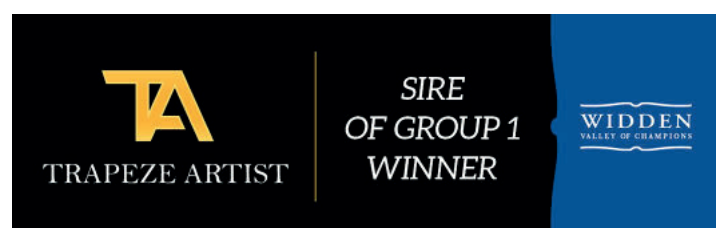

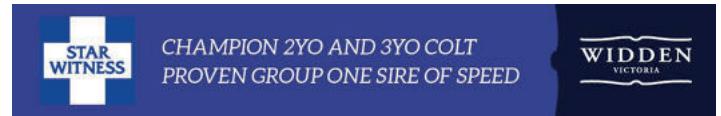

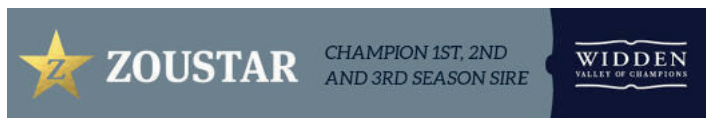
