Orchestral's sister hits the \$2.4 million top note at Karaka

Daughter of Savabeel becomes the most expensive filly ever sold in New Zealand when going to Mulcaster and Waller

By Lydia Symonds

Orchestral's (Savabeel) sister became the most expensive filly ever sold at New Zealand Bloodstock's Karaka Yearling Sale when Guy Mulcaster and Chris Waller came out on top of a spirited bidding dual to snare the filly for an eye-watering \$2.4 million on Monday.

When New Zealand Bloodstock released the catalogue for their Karaka Yearling Sale the Haunui Farm-offered filly became the focal point and one of the most talked about horses in the run up to the sale. The interest jacked up when dual Group 1 winner Orchestral stormed back into form in Saturday's Aotearoa Classic (Listed, 1600m) at Ellerslie.

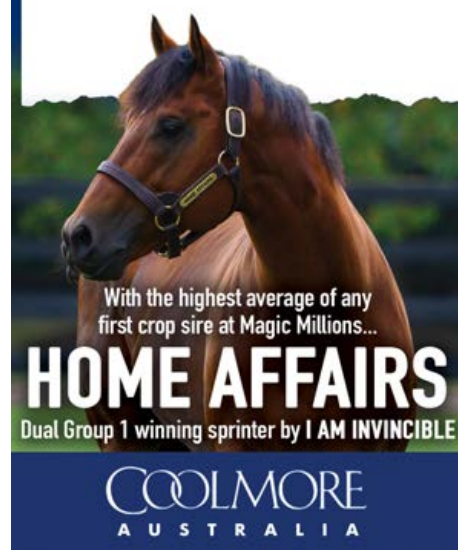

Dream result for Lawson

Waikato Stud team member Simon Lawson accomplished a remarkable result on day two of selling at the 2025 Karaka National Yearling Sale, turning the first foal out of \$500 bargain buy mare Serenella (Jimmy Choux) into a stunning \$300,000 sales ring result, writes Tayla Dyke.

Starting the bidding at \$300,000, the money came flying in from different directions for the filly. As the price soared past the million mark, the other parties dropped away, leaving Bruce Wilson's Glentree Thoroughbreds and the Mulcaster / Waller camp to fight it out for the youngster. As the bidding flashed \$2.3 million, Mulcaster landed the final blow, to secure the filly on behalf of owner Glenn Ritchie.

Barneswood Farm's Sarah Green, who bred the session-topper with Ger Beemsterboer, was visibly emotional during the bidding and described the moment as a 'fairytale'.

"We were expecting interest, but never at that price - this is a fairytale," she said. "My first dad died when I was six months old and he was a jockey. My stepfather was an owner-trainer and I just keep thinking how proud they would be.

"I never wanted to sell this filly but my husband talked me into it, so he is off the hook now.

"This is just incredible. I always thought when you breed a horse and you sell it you don't get the same thrill from watching them, but you absolutely do - she is still like our baby and I am sure Betty, who I named at birth, will still be as exciting.

"They thought she was perhaps a wee bit smaller [than Orchestral], but she has got that residual value, even if she doesn't race.

"We were told there were five big players up to our reserve and then maybe three that would go above it. We were hoping to get \$1 million, it would have been our first ever sale that high, but to go that high is unbelievable."

Green sold New Zealand Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) and Vinery Stud Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) winner Orchestral to her trainers, Roger James and Robert Wellwood, for \$625,000 at the 2022 edition of the same sale. The breeder has another sister out of four-time winner Symphonic (O'Reilly), who she will retain.

"We have a full-sister at foot, so I will keep that one," she said.

"I love my racing, my racing partner from the Netherlands [Beemsterboer] loves his breeding, but you have got to have both. We get a different enjoyment out of it and I love the racing side of it - I don't so much the breeding side of it because you have got to sell your babies, it's like selling your children, but this dampens the pain."

Reflecting on the price he had to go to in order to secure the filly, former coach operator Ritchie said: "From a personal point of view I kind of look at it and say '\$2.4 million - that is only three new buses' and you think what the hell."

"After we sold the business my wife said to me 'what do you want to do?' and I said 'I wouldn't mind getting a racehorse'."

"We have got over 20 with Chris [Waller] and we own 100 per cent of ownership of the whole lot. We are not into syndication because it becomes too unwieldy."

As well as the horses he has with Waller, Ritchie races Miss Ziggy (Brazen Beau) who finished third in Saturday's Karaka Millions 2YO (RL, 1200m) at Ellerslie. The daughter of Brazen Beau (I Am Invincible) was

bought by her trainer Andrew Carston on behalf of the owner for \$250,000 at Book 1 of the same sale last year.

While Orchestral is the stand-out on the page, the filly hails from a family that packs a punch with stakes winners right through the pedigree.

Symphonic herself is out of the unraced mare Chorus (Danasinga), whose other daughter, Glee (O'Reilly), produced this season's impressive New Zealand 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Savaglee (Savabeel). Further back, this is also the family of top flight-winning trio Good Faith (Straight Strike), Aegon (Sacred Falls), Daffodil (No Excuse Needed) and Atishu (Savabeel).

To add a further dimension to an already potent pedigree, the filly is bred on the Savabeel / O'Reilly cross, one of the strongest nicks in the Stud Book and one that has yielded 34 individual stakes winners, a list headed by ten elite-level winners.

Monday's top-price means the filly became the second-most expensive horse ever sold at Karaka, with the auction house record held by subsequent Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) winner Don Eduardo (Zabeel), who Cambridge Stud sold to Gooree Stud for a massive \$3.6 million in 2000.

The \$2.4 million brought by the filly means she is the most expensive yearling by Waikato Stud's marquee stallion Savabeel (Zabeel) ever sold, smashing his previous record of \$1.4 million, which David Ellis paid for No Limits in 2019.

Continued from page 5 Mulcaster told ANZ Bloodstock News that they inspected a collection of the best bred fillies on the complex and said the session-topper had the looks to match her outstanding pedigree.

“I looked at all the best bred fillies here and I thought she was the best physical to match the beautiful pedigree, so that was what got us fired up. Chris [Waller] looked at her quite a few times and we both agreed that she was probably the pick,” he said.

“We took our clients to see her this morning and we were lucky enough they buttered up and stumped up the money. We’ve been beaten on a few good fillies over the past couple of years. When they’ve got a good page and the physical to match, they’re going to make their money.

“She’s a lovely Savabeel who has a bit of growing to do, but she’s got a big deep girth so fingers crossed.”

Haunui Farm began the day on a positive note when they sold another daughter of Savabeel to Dean Hawthorne for \$400,000.

The filly is out of the Group 1-placed winner Rondinella (Ocean Park), whose colt by Snitzel (Redoute’s Choice) sold for \$825,000 to David Ellis at last year’s edition of the sale. That colt is now known as He Who Dares and he broke his maiden on the first attempt when he landed a 1200-metre maiden at Wanganui on January 20.

Rondinella herself is out of Group 3 winner Valpolicella (Red Ransom), who is also the dam of Group 2-winning duo Vilanova (Commands) and Vavasour (Redoute’s Choice), while she also produced Group 3 scorer Celebrity Dream (Thorn Park).

Hawthorne said he was keen to get his hands on a well-credentialed filly to stay in New Zealand, believing well-bred fillies to be a rare commodity with so many of them being lost to Australia.

“It was the residual value that drew me to her. Fillies in New Zealand with residual value are becoming rarer because of the offshore competition across the Tasman to get them because everyone loves a good New Zealand family.

“This filly will stay in New Zealand because she’s been bought for a client here. It is great for the industry that people can buy these good fillies - it’s what our industry needs because our good pedigrees disappear offshore because of the quality of our racehorses and they go and win their Oaks and mile races and recently there have been some nice 1400-metre fillies race over there.

“The colt last year made \$725,000 and the early reports from Te Akau are great on him and he’s a lovely horse.”

Haunui Farm’s Mark Chitty told ANZ Bloodstock News that he was happy to meet the market and see her go to a good home.

“She is a lovely filly,” he said. “Rondinella was one hell of a racemare and one hell of a producer. Maybe overshadowed by the Symphonic filly but we were happy to meet the market and we let the market decide.

“When you get beyond her sort of value you don’t have to miss by much to be friendless. We are enormously proud of Rondinella and her filly has gone to a great home.”

Proisir filly makes \$700,000

Duncan Ramage, John Sargent Racing and Brad Spicer combined on day two of the Karaka yearling sale to buy a filly by Proisir (Choisir) from the Curraghmore draft for \$700,000.

The filly is out of the Listed winner Strada Cavallo (Alamosa) making her a half-sister to this season’s VRC Oaks (Gr 1, 2500m) runner-up Powers Of Opal (Ocean Park), who Ramage and Sargent purchased for \$130,000 at the corresponding sale 12 months ago.

Sargent said the filly looked ‘identical’ to her half-sister and stablemate.

“She was identical to Powers Of Opal, but she’ll probably take a little bit more time as she is a late foal, but that’s what we hope with Powers Of Opal, that she will have a good autumn and put more value on to this pedigree,” the trainer said.

“She will go to Curraghmore for a couple of months and then be broken in and then go over [to Australia].

Ramage has enjoyed enormous success buying at Karaka over the years, most notably having bought So You Think (High Chaparral) in the same ring for \$110,000 in 2008. However, the last filly he bought at Karaka for \$700,000 was First Seal (Fastnet Rock), whose win in the Surround Stakes (Gr 2 1400m) of 2015 was the third time she won a race when she had Winx (Street Cry) behind her.

“She’s a very athletic filly and much like Powers Of Opal and with her in the family we already have a lot of residual value with this filly. The last filly we bought here for \$700,000 was First Seal, so we’re hoping she can follow in her footsteps,” Ramage said.

Curraghmore Stud enjoyed another brilliant day’s trade and closed day two having sold 14 yearlings for an aggregate of \$4,040,000, at an average of \$288,571.

Gordon Cunningham told ANZ Bloodstock News that they had always had a good opinion of the filly and expected her to be well found.

“She is a filly we have always had a high opinion of, much like her sister, Powers of Opal,” he said. “She presented great, was very popular with several good judges and bought by Duncan Ramage and John Sargent. They are very excited about what the autumn will bring for Powers of Opal and now they have her sister, so we wish them the best of luck.”

A little later on in the session, another filly by Rich Hill’s resident stallion proved popular when she was bought by TFI, Michael Freedman Fillies and Michael Wallace for \$560,000. Offered by Highline Thoroughbreds, the filly is out of All Can Party (All American), making her a half-sister to Group 1 winner Dark Destroyer (Proisir).

The filly’s breeders, Warwick and Kelly Jeffries, were elated with Monday’s result,

“We couldn’t fault her as she is a great moving filly with a superb temperament. She paraded a lot but nothing phased her. She loves to please and is unflappable,” Warwick told ANZ Bloodstock News.

“We are rapt with who bought her. She will get every chance of being with a great trainer. There was no real surprise regarding her price and she deserved to make good money.”

Wootton Bassett’s popularity continues at Karaka

After making a strong start on the first day at Karaka, Coolmore’s star shuttler Wootton Bassett (Iffraaj) continued to garner strong competition and his headline horse during the second session was a colt who was bought by Paul Chow of Tartan Meadow Bloodstock for \$600,000.

Chow admitted he didn’t expect the colt to make the money he did, but given the strong start the stallion has made with his first crop of southern hemisphere-bred yearlings, he said there was a fair bit of momentum surrounding the sire.

“I personally think it’s a bit overpriced and it’s got a lot to do with the recent success of Wootton Bassetts. You know how it is in this industry, you’ve got a few horses of an up-and-coming sire and suddenly he does very well, and with a sale it has a major impact on the pricing.”

Wootton Bassett has made a blistering start with his first runners in the southern hemisphere siring three winners from eight starters, including the talented stakes-placed Gallo Nero and Wodeton, who broke his maiden at Rosehill on January 18 and is now favourite for the Golden Slipper (Gr 1, 1200m) in March.

However, those numbers only tell half the stallion’s story. His first southern hemisphere-bred runners come hot on the heels of an incredible year with his juveniles in the north, the first crop conceived at Coolmore Stud.

The stallion was crowned the Champion European Two-Year-Old Sire in 2024, having recorded an impressive 42 winners, with 13 of those winning at stakes level, headed by Group 1 scorers Twain, Henri Matisse, Camille Pissarro and Tennessee Stud.

Chow said the colt would stay in New Zealand and could possibly end up in Hong Kong in the future.

“He’s going to stay in New Zealand for now, do the pre-training, trialling and all that and if he makes a grade, he’ll go to Hong Kong.”

Chow said the competition for the top end yearlings at the sale had been very strong.

“The sale is pretty much like recent sales in recent years, the top end is very competitive. I think the middle, lower end is probably a little bit weaker than last year.

“I may be wrong, it’s just my feeling, I haven’t looked at the numbers yet. But the top end is certainly very competitive. I lost out on a couple of bids.”

Offered by Blandford Lodge, the colt is the first foal out of Aspen Colorado (Proisir), who finished third in the New Zealand Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m).

At the close of day two, Wootton Bassett is the leading sire by average having sold seven yearlings for an average of \$433,571.

Dream result for Lawson

Waikato Stud team member Simon Lawson accomplished a remarkable result on day two of selling at the 2025 Karaka National Yearling Sale, turning the first foal out of \$500 bargain buy mare Serenella (Jimmy Choux) into a stunning \$300,000 sales ring result, *writes Tayla Dyke*.

The former Group 1-winning harness racing driver switched industries just five years ago, and having begun working at Waikato Stud, purchased a share in young resident sire Noverre (Snitzel) before setting out on a search to secure a mare to send to the first-season sire.

Lawson purchased the unraced Serenella, who herself is a three-quarter sister to three-time Group 1-winner The Bostonian, for \$500 via Gavelhouse.com.

"I own a share in Noverre and I was looking for a mare that was suitable for him. I loved her grandmother, Keepa Cheval, who is the mother of The Bostonian, we had her at the farm there for a while," said Lawson.

"She came up online and she had a few injuries, she had broken her wither and her knee, and that is probably why she was so cheap."

Offered by Waikato Stud, the colt was purchased by Wexford Stables and Lawson was understandably delighted by the outcome.

"I loved the mare, I loved the stallion too and they produced a lovely colt. For him to make \$300,000 and to go to Wexford is a dream come true," Lawson said.

"There were a lot of good stables on him. He was going to find a nice home, but I am stoked he is going to Wexford.

"To get a result like that, the whole team are just so stoked and have worked so hard for me with my horse, it is just brilliant."

Lawson said he is now fully immersed in the thoroughbred breeding world, and is committed to the industry and Waikato Stud for the long haul.

"I have been there [Waikato Stud] five years now and I will be there forever, it is just a great joint. Mark, Garry, Pip and Mary [Chittick] have looked after me so well," he said.

"I have two mares of my own now and myself and our vet Matt [MacKee] have one together as well.

"I have got a full-brother to this guy to sell next year, and potentially another colt, so I am looking forward to that."

Sales statistics after day two

At the close of trade on the second session of Book 1, New Zealand Bloodstock reported the aggregate was \$56,830,000, down 3.5 per cent at the same stage 12 months earlier, while the clearance rate was the same at 77 per cent.

The average fell 2.9 per cent to sit at \$171, 692, while the median was recorded at \$120,000, a 14.3 per cent drop on last year's figure after the second day of selling.

"It was just a magical day. To achieve a result like that, \$2.4 million just for amazing people and breeders in Barneswood Farm and great supporters of New Zealand bloodstock, Haunui Farm. It was really exciting and the emotion during and immediately afterwards was pretty special and pretty overwhelming as well," said NZB's bloodstock sales manager, Kane Jones.

"It's always really hard to value these high priced horses, because the number of people that can bid at that level is pretty limited, but they're always strong when they do like a horse.

"We were thinking she could get past a million, but to get to \$2.4 million took everybody by surprise. It's the highest priced filly to ever walk through the ring here at Karaka and the second-highest priced yearling ever sold - it was just a magical moment.

"The clearance rate yesterday [Sunday] was about 73 per cent and we're up to just over 76 per cent now for the two days. That's probably a reflection of vendors just finding out where their level is in the sale. Everyone is working hard behind the scenes on both sides of the ledger, so we're pleased with that."

The final day of Book 1 begins at 10am (NZT) on Tuesday.

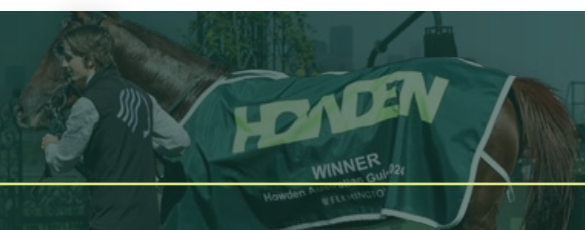

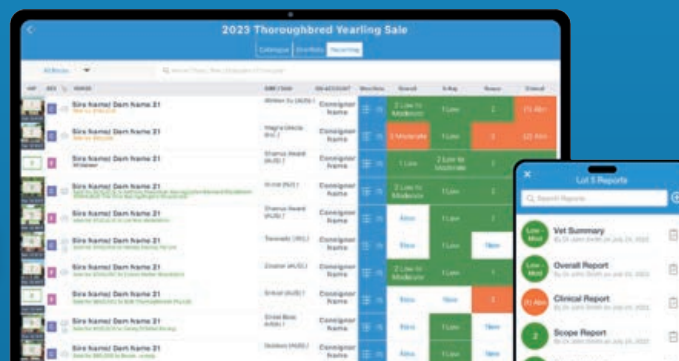

Morning Briefing

Australia

44 for Australia

Tajanis (5 g ex Baheejah by Dubawi) became the 44th individual stakes winner for Coolmore's Australia (Galileo) when he continued his upward trajectory by winning the \$200,000 Australia Day Cup (Listed, 2400m) at Warwick Farm on Monday. The Chris Waller-trained import was able to make it back-to-back victories over 2400 metres after his win in a Benchmark 78 at Rosehill on his previous start, claiming his first stakes win by 0.7 lengths under Zac Lloyd. Recent Flemington winner Taramansour (Dansili) was second, while last-start January Cup (Listed, 2000m) third Saltcoats (Ardrossan) filled that same position again, a further 3.7 lengths behind. Tajanis was bought by Go Racing for 40,000gns from the 2023 Tattersalls Horses in Training Sale in the UK, where he was offered as a Yarmouth maiden winner. Bred by Godolphin out of the stakes-placed Baheejah (Dubawi), the five-year-old is a half-brother to the Group 1-placed stakes winner Jabaara (Exceed And Excel). Australia will stand the northern hemisphere breeding season at a fee of €10,000 (approx. AU\$16,655).

Caulfield calling for Coeur Volante

Mike Moroney and Glen Thompson have been patient with promising Proisir (Choisir) mare Coeur Volante, who is set to begin her latest campaign in the Geoffrey Bellmaine Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) at Caulfield on Saturday. The four-year-old hasn't raced since finishing sixth in the Dane Ripper Stakes (Gr 2, 1300m) at Eagle Farm in June, and Thompson explained that after some minor issues, the mare had an extended break in Queensland. "She is in good order, jumping out well at Flemington and Werribee," Thompson said. "We took her to Brisbane, but she didn't do well in the spring, so we wanted to give her a good break. She was up there for around a dozen weeks. She looks good, she's not big but she's held onto her condition and hopefully that time pays off." Coeur Volante

showed early promise, including a strong first-up win in the Champagne Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) at The Valley in September 2023 and a victory in the Thousand Guineas Prelude (Gr 2, 1400m) a month later at Caulfield, before her fourth-placed finish in the Thousand Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m). Saturday's run will guide her trainers as to where Coeur Volante will head this campaign, but the hope is that she can line up for the Group 1 mares' races in Sydney. "I think the Coolmore [Classic] has been spoken about but it's one race at a time," Thompson said. "She needs to be winning something first before we go to a race like that."

Nominations extended for Rosehill features

Nominations for the three black type races at Rosehill on Saturday have been extended after 12 nominations were received on Monday for the \$250,000 Southern Cross Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) and 11 nominations were each received for the juvenile sprints, the \$250,000 Widden Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) and the \$160,000 Canonbury Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m). The full ten-race program at Rosehill has 178 nominations, with the track rated a Good 4 on Monday. The extension comes just days after the Carrington Stakes (Listed, 1400m) was dropped from last Saturday's Randwick card due to the race attracting insufficient entries.

Another Wil set to kick off in Orr

Another Wil (Street Boss) is set for a first-up run in elite-level company after the five-year-old pleased connections in his Cranbourne jump-out on Monday. The Orr Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Caulfield on February 8 has been circled as the autumn starting point for the three-time stakes winner, who was edged out by Kimochi (Brave Smash) last time out in the Sir Rupert Clarke Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) on November 16. "We moved him up to the 1200-metre [jump-out] to get on better ground," Jack Turnbull, assistant to Ciaran Maher, told Racing.com. "He was heat one and Celine [Gaudray] came

in and rode him and he put in a nice piece of work. We're really pleased with where he's at. He'll do something on the Monday leading into that [Orr Stakes] on the bridle. [His] weight's good and he looks good and he was a head away from being a Group 1 winner last prep, so hopefully we can hit the ground running." Another Wil is set for an ambitious preparation should his form hold-up into the autumn. "He gives us every indication that he is a future Group 1 horse, but sometimes it doesn't work out that way," Turnbull continued. "Hopefully he remains sound and in the right head space. He's one that loses weight at times, we're mindful of that, but at this point of time he's in a reasonable spot and hopefully that holds."

Duke De Sessa to resume at Caulfield

Joining Another Wil in his Cranbourne jump-out on Monday was Caulfield Cup (Gr 1, 2400m) hero Duke De Sessa (Lope De Vega), who finished runner-up in the 1200-metre heat behind his stablemate. Duke De Sessa is set to kick off his campaign in the TS Carlyon Cup (Gr 3, 1600m) back at Caulfield on February 8. "He had a really quiet jump-out for his first when he went back and he was held onto, but today he did a little over 1200 [metres], so he'll be right to kick off in the Carlyon Cup, which is a mile race at Caulfield," assistant trainer Jack Turnbull said. "He'll probably head to Sydney after that for a race like the Parramatta Cup over 1900 metres with his main aim being the Tancred [Stakes]."

Inglis Millennium next for Cavalry Girl

Exciting juvenile filly Cavalry Girl (Bivouac) is set to make her next start in the Inglis Millennium (RL, 1100m) at Randwick on February 8. The Bivouac (Exceed And Excel) filly pleased her trainer Tom Dabernig in a gallop at Warrnambool on Saturday as part of her preparation for the \$2 million sprint. "She galloped the reverse way on the grass and went well. I was quite pleased, she was very natural and did it easily," Dabernig told Racing.com. "At this stage she will do it again on Tuesday and head to Randwick on Wednesday. She can settle in and then she will have a gallop on the Tuesday before the race." Linda Meech has ridden Cavalry Girl in her two starts to date for a second in the Geelong Diamond (1100m) to Cherish Me (Brazen Beau) before a maiden win at Flemington over 1000 metres on January 18. Meech will continue the partnership with the filly in the Inglis Millennium, for which Cavalry Girl is rated a \$7 chance. "She [Cavalry Girl] is professional in everything she does," Dabernig added. "It's not easy for Victorian horses to go to Sydney, but I think she's the one who could." Next month's Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) is also still a possibility for Cavalry Girl. "It depends on how she goes," her trainer said. "It's two weeks later - it's a bit of an ask but still doable. If she performed well and pulled up well, I wouldn't rule it out."

Bedggood hoping to strike in Lightning with Mornington Glory

A trip to Dubai is likely off the table for Group 1-winning sprinter Mornington Glory (Shalaa), who will instead be aimed at resuming in Flemington's Black Caviar Lightning Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m) next month. A potential tilt at the Al Quoz Sprint (Gr 1, 1200m) at Meydan in April posed several challenges according to the Moir Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner's trainer Gavin Bedggood, with connections now more likely to seek the 1000-metre feature on February 15. "We received an invite to Dubai but logistically it's been a bit of a nightmare, so we might go to the Lightning first-up and stay in Australia," Bedggood told Racing.com. Connections have not however ruled out a Royal Ascot bid for the

speedster, and good showing first-up would keep that option open. Mornington Glory won his eight-runner jump-out at Cranbourne on Monday. "I thought he trialled great," Bedggood said. "You wouldn't expect anything less. He's normally pretty fast in these jump-outs and he showed his customary speed and trialled accordingly. He's still got condition, so he'll definitely need another. Whether we go to Moe next Thursday or trial here in a fortnight, that should top him off." A Sydney campaign will be considered for the gelding, with the Challenge Stakes (Gr 2, 1000m) and The Galaxy (Gr 1, 1100m) likely options.

Australian Guineas on the agenda for Captured By Love

New Zealand 1,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Captured By Love (Written Tycoon) is being aimed at the Australian Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) at Flemington on March 1 by her trainers Mark Walker and Sam Bergerson. Walker has revealed that the filly will head over to Melbourne in the coming weeks after her last-start seventh in the Railway Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m), where she was beaten 2.3 lengths by Crocetti (Zacinto) on the Soft 5 surface. "She'll make her way over shortly to Melbourne for the Australian Guineas," Walker told Racing.com. "She's a very good filly and it was just a shame the track was too wet for her in the Railway on Saturday."

Sydney start likely for Giga Kick

Mornington-based trainer Clayton Douglas has revealed stable star Giga Kick (Scissor Kick) is back in pre-training work at his stable, as the dual Group 1 winner gears up for a return to the trials. "I do everything with him," Douglas said. "I've got a treadmill, there's a pool, there's a water-walker just up the road. I just do a bit of alternative work with him to keep him active and busy." Douglas is considering kicking off the five-year-old gelding's campaign in the TJ Smith Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) at Randwick in April before extending it to Queensland during the winter. "He did well in his break, as you would expect as he's a bit older now," Douglas said. "There's nothing planned out for him yet, but he'll most likely head up to Sydney, but

we'll just poke through the next five or six weeks and get back to the jump-outs and take it from there. He's carrying a bit of condition which is good. He raced right through to the end of the spring, and he's come back really well. I don't know whether I'll give him three trials or two, but that could determine where he kicks off, and he could go to the TJ Smith first-up. It will all be determined by how he comes up and if he's nice and fit and well, he will head to the races and if he needs an extra couple of weeks, we'll give it to him."

Group 1 goals for Charm Stone

Having run a bold race to be second in the \$2 million Magic Millions Cup (RL, 1400m) at the Gold Coast last time out, the Mick Price and Michael Kent Jnr-trained Charm Stone (I Am Invincible) will return to Group 1 level during the Adelaide carnival. "We need to sit down and work out how to get there but we'll put a big circle on the Robert Sangster against the girls and then the Goodwood and see if we can make her a Group 1 winner," Kent Jnr told Racing.com. Reflecting on Charm Stone's most recent run, he continued: "Maybe the 1400 metres saw her out, but I still believe she gets that distance although she may be more effective over 1200 metres and 1300 metres. She was eight weeks between runs and it was also her first preparation back from over a year off. I think in the next preparation she will be better again as there was a bit of rustiness there because she did take a while to sort of get back in the groove. I think she's going as well as ever now, so it's onwards and upwards."

I Am Invincible pair catch the eye

Champion sire I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit) sired back-to-back three-year-old winners at Warwick Farm on Monday, beginning with the Peter Snowden-trained La Roja who scored at the second time of asking in an 1100-metre contest. Having finished seventh in the Lonhro Plate (Listed, 1000m) on debut, the filly showed improved form after an 11-month break to beat She Swings (Trapeze Artist) by 0.7 lengths, with a further 0.3 lengths back to Mia Ballerina (Cosmic Force) in third. "She has always shown us good ability, but really needed that extra time to mature," Snowden said. "She's almost the finished product now, but we'll take it one step at a time." La Roja was purchased for \$900,000 by Snowden Racing, William Johnson Bloodstock, Cunningham Thoroughbreds and Clarke Bloodstock out of the Newgate Farm draft at the 2023 Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale. I Am Invincible rounded off his double when the Ciaran Maher-trained Railway Man broke his maiden in a 1400-metre \$100,000 super maiden. The colt proved game in the hands of Jason Collett, defeating Automne Tree (The Autumn Sun) by 0.3 lengths with a further 1.4 lengths back to the third-placed Bernen Win (Shooting To Win). Railway Man was purchased by his trainer for \$2.5 million out of Coolmore's draft at the 2023 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale and he runs for a partnership that includes Coolmore. He is the first foal out of the Oakleigh Plate (Gr 1, 1100m) winner Booker (Written Tycoon), who was bought by Tom Magnier for \$1.6 million at the 2020 Inglis Chairman's Sale and her second foal, a filly also by I Am Invincible, sold for \$3 million at the 2024 Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale to John Stewart's Resolute Racing.

Winx foal 'going brilliantly'

Debbie Kepitis has provided an update on Winx's (Street Cry) latest Snitzel (Redoute's Choice) foal after being in New Zealand on Saturday to watch her homebred Konasana (Dundeel) land the Westbury Stud Classic (Gr 2, 1400m) at Ellerslie. "They are going great. He is a bit of a feisty thing. He wants more from mum," Kepitis told Racing.com. "She gives him the back ears and a leg touch. They're

going brilliantly." The Snitzel colt's half-sister by Piero (Lonhro), now named Quinceanera, was purchased back as a yearling by part-owner Kepitis for a record \$10 million in Sydney last April.

Group 1 winner Spriggs making progress

Group 1-winning jockey Blake Spriggs is reportedly making progress after he was seriously injured in a race fall at Moruya on January 17. Spriggs was taken to Royal Canberra Hospital where he has been intubated since. "Many fractures in his ribs. Major collarbone and arm fracture. Surgery on those were successful," Dustin Spriggs, the rider's brother, posted on X. "Punctured lungs are still the focus but all the bleeding from them has eased. Doctors assured us that this is common for trauma patients with ICU. He was heavily sedated with ketamine yesterday for the fact that they didn't want him coughing with the extent of his broken ribs and lungs."

Matamata's Champagne Stakes the aim for Imprevu

Janenne Dalley is eyeing a trip to Matamata for the Lisa Chittick Champagne Stakes (Listed, 1400m) on February 15 with Imprevu (Wrote) after the six-year-old came within 0.1 length of causing a major boilover in last Saturday's Westbury Stud Classic (Gr 2, 1400m). The six-year-old had been in pleasing form heading into the Ellerslie race, finishing runner-up to Babylon Berlin (All Too Hard) in the Legacy Lodge Sprint (Listed, 1200m) at Te Rapa in November and posting fourth placings in the J Swap Sprint (Gr 3, 1400m) and Royal Descent Stakes (1400m), before then finishing runner-up to Group 1 winner Captured By Love (Written Tycoon) in a 1000-metre trial

at Matamata earlier this month. "She had improved a lot since Boxing Day [Royal Descent Stakes] and that trial at Matamata just topped her off. She was the best I had her all season," Dalley said. "We were very confident. Earlier on we were looking at the Railway and then once we knew all of those younger horses were going to be in there, we decided we would go to the fillies and mares race [Westbury]. We weren't surprised with the run, she got a beautiful run and Tayla [Mitchell] rode her a peach. She has come through the run great. We are looking at the Lisa Chittick. We got third in it last year with Impresa, her half-sister."

Five-time Group winner Bonny Lass retired

After a formidable career competing at the highest level, Graham Richardson and Rogan Norvall's star mare Bonny Lass (Super Easy) has been retired from racing. A daughter of Super Easy (Darci Brahma), Bonny Lass landed the first of five Group victories in the Matamata Breeders' Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) as a juvenile. At three, she won the Cambridge Breeders' Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m), a trend she continued into her four-year-old preparation when picking up the Sweeney Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m). Having come close to breaking her Group 1 duck, that wait came to a triumphant end in last February's BCD Group Sprint (Gr 1, 1400m), where she downed Crocetti (Zacinto) by 0.2 lengths to snatch top honours. Opening her final season with a bang, Bonny Lass returned to Te Rapa and won the Foxbridge Plate (Gr 2, 1200m), and after finishing eighth in the Railway Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) last Saturday, the curtain came down on a phenomenal 28-start career. "She was a natural from day one," Richardson said. "The only two horses to have won Group races at two, three, four, five and six are her and Melody Belle. I couldn't be prouder. She's going to be really missed. I don't know what the plan of attack is now, but she'll go back to Hallmark Stud, then Sandy Moore, who owns her, will decide that. Whether he will sell her or breed from her, I'm not sure, it's all up in the air, but she'll be looked after, which she deserves." Bonny Lass ends her career with eight wins and a further eight placings, with \$774,950 earned in prize-money.



HK: Healthy Happy ready to deliver

Group 3 winner Healthy Happy (Zoustar) will be out to add to his tally when the Frankie Lor-trained eight-year-old lines up in Friday's Chinese New Year Cup Handicap (1400m)

at Sha Tin. The gelding won the Hong Kong Classic Cup (Listed, 1800m) in his rookie season as a four-year-old, and further improved in his five-year-old campaign, making his Group-race breakthrough by winning the Chinese Club Challenge Cup (Gr 3, 1400m). He added another Group 3 victory in last season's Celebration Cup (Gr 3, 1400m) and Lor admitted that 1400 metres is the horse's ideal distance. "1200 metres is too short but a mile is a bit long for him, and therefore we have always planned Friday's feature as his target," the trainer said. "Last start he raced in a strong Group 3 race [Chinese Club Challenge Cup] but he was not beaten far. It will be an easier race for him this Friday. The only concern is the weight – and therefore I decided to put apprentice Ellis Wong on who has a seven-pound claim. He always runs well fresh. But on his current rating he should be very competitive and I am pleased with his condition now. If he

can race comfortably in the front he should be thereabouts."

QAT: Dubai Honour off on his travels again

Globetrotter Dubai Honour (Pride Of Dubai) is set to break new ground next month after he figured among a strong overseas entry for the HH Amir's Trophy (Gr 3, 2400m) at Doha on February 15. The seven-year-old is a three-time Group 1 winner, including the Ranvet Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) and Queen Elizabeth Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m), and was last seen finishing second to fellow British raider Giavellotto (Mastercraftsman) in the Hong Kong Vase (Gr 1, 2400m) at Sha Tin in December. Dubai Honour's trainer William Haggas said: "We have two for the meeting. Dubai Honour is being aimed at the Amir's Trophy, while Yarough is in the Group 2 Irish Thoroughbred Marketing Cup."

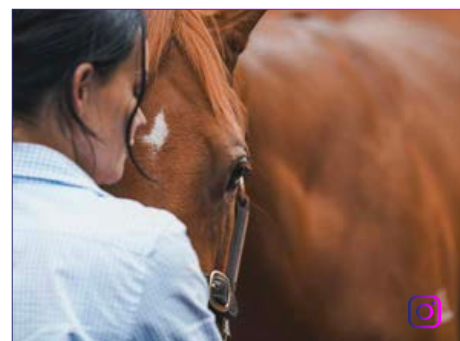

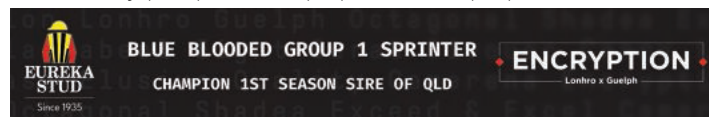
