LEGACY COOLMORE STUD STAKES **BOUND AFTER FLEMINGTON VICTORY**

CAULFIELD STAKES ON THE TABLE FOR IMPRESSIVE VINROCK

Mr Brightside caps off a huge day for Lindsay Park with historic Makybe Diva victory

Brightside (Bullbars) enhanced his reputation as a people's horse when he benefitted from a Craig Williams riding lesson to secure a tenth elitelevel success in Saturday's Makybe Diva Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m).

Williams gave his five rival jockeys a clinic in the Flemington feature, being allowed to set a crawling pace on the eight-year-old Mr Brightside, who was sent out an easing \$5 equal second elect behind the raging \$1.80 favourite Via Sistina (Fastnet Rock) and James

Mr Brightside flopped into the lead from the start and cruised a length or more in front from the 1400m to the 600m with sectionals of 12.82 seconds, 13.01, 12.94 and 12.22. Tom Kitten (Harry Angel) was one rival unhappy with the pace, pulling for his head in stages near the back of the pack, yet none of the chasing jockeys opted to put pressure on the leader. Continued from page 1 The 48-year-old Williams let Mr Brightside go entering the straight and, full of running and with his rivals powerless to catch him, he dashed away to a three-length lead by the 200 metres, and ultimately scored by 1.5 lengths.

ATC Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) winner Aeliana (Castelvecchio), also at \$5, performed solidly second-up to take second, with Via Sistina 0.4 lengths further back in third.

While questions were asked of rival jockeys, Ben, JD and Will Hayes could once again toast the most special horse of their time so far in charge of Lindsay Park as Mr Brightside extended his remarkable record.

Bought from Phoenix Park's draft by Phill Cataldo Bloodstock at the Karaka May Sale of 2019 for just \$22,000, Mr Brightside has now earned \$17.97 million.

He's one of three stakes winners, and the only one west of the Tasman, from 109 runners for Bullbars (Elusive Quality) - who moved from New Zealand to South Australia in 2020, covered less than 20 mares in each of three seasons, and disappeared from the stud book after 2022, when just 15.

Mr Brightside's unraced dam Lilahjay (Tavistock) has produced just the one stakes winner from six foals to race, though to be fair all of them have been winners, with two others scoring in metro class.

Despite these humble pedigree notes, Mr Brightside has - as an emotional Williams noted - earned a place in the hearts of a legion of racing fans, enhanced with his third successive Makybe Diva Stakes success on Saturday.

He became the first male horse to win three successive editions of a Flemington Group 1, following four females. Makybe Diva (Desert King) herself of course won three Melbourne Cups (Gr 1, 3200m), Black Caviar (Bel Esprit) took three straight runnings of the Lightning Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m), and - before the modern pattern system - Tranquil Star (Gay Lothario) and Wakeful (Trenton) each raised a Mackinnon Stakes hat-trick.

"This horse, he just carries so many racing fans and people," Williams told Racing.com of the gelding named after the hit song by The Killers.

"If you love the song, you've got him as well. He's just really captivated people around Australia.

"He's the best, or one of the best milers in Australia on his day. He's the best on his day and one of the best when he's not. He's just a marvel.

"I'm very blessed, very privileged to be a part of this horse, a part of his development which gives me great pride.

"The Hayes boys, I rode for their father, their uncle, their grandfather and what they're doing with these equine stars is amazing."

Ben Hayes paid tribute to Williams - and of course to Mr Brightside, now a 20-time winner from 46 starts.

He cheekily called the durable gelding "technically" an 11-time Group 1 winner, having also taken Melbourne's All-Star Mile (1600m) in 2023, two years before it achieved top-tier status, while also highlighting the horse's 11 Group 1 placings.

"It turned out beautifully. It was a ten-outof-ten ride," Hayes said. "Tactically, he got an easy time early and because he got an easy time, they couldn't catch him, a champion like him.

"To win three Makybe Divas and make it ten Group 1s, he's an amazing horse and we're so lucky to have him."

"We thought he had gone the right way. He paraded beautifully, it was typical Mr B. His coat has come on, but the good thing is, he's got improvement to come and we're going to have fun placing him at his next couple of starts.

"I'm so proud of him and for him to come back and win, to show how good he is, makes Our Team

us so proud. For JD and Will and I, he's the most special horse we've ever had.

"He's an absolute champion, no one can deny that now and maybe people will start respecting him, and tipping him."

Hayes said a second bid for a Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) - in which Mr Brightside ran a 0.1-length second to the great Romantic Warrior (Acclamation) in 2023 - was not out of the question.

But he indicated 1600-metre races would be more suitable. This could include the Feehan Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m) at Moonee Valley on September 26, or Randwick's King Charles III Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) on October 18.

"He's so good over a mile," Hayes said.
"[The Cox Plate] is still an option and I'll have to talk to my brothers, and do what we believe is the best result for him.

"We'll definitely consider it [the Feehan]. That's probably the logical race, if not he might have a trial and go to the King Charles III."

Mr Brightside's win also capped a huge day for the stable, which also took the Bobbie Lewis Quality (Gr 2, 1200m) with Arkansaw Kid (Harry Angel) and the Tontonan Stakes (Listed, 1400m) with Cafe Millenium (Not A Single Doubt).

Jockey Damian Lane said Star Thoroughbreds' Aeliana had run "super".

"Travelled up great, just outsprinted by Mr Brightside, who obviously had it very easy and sprinted too sharp," Lane said.

McDonald said of Via Sistina: "Very good run. Sit and sprint, she dashed well."

Lilahjay died last year, aged 12. Her last foal is a yearling colt by Satono Aladdin (Deep Impact).

Tempted adds to Godolphin's impressive Run To The Rose record

Flying filly Tempted (Street Boss) showed her rare class with a dominant victory over a field of males in Saturday's Run To The Rose (Gr 2, 1200m) at Rosehill, extending Godolphin's extraordinary record in the race and also put herself in calculations for The Everest (Gr 1, 1200m).

Despite being the only female among the dozen three-year-olds competing, the Golden Slipper (Gr 1, 1200m) third placegetter was backed strongly from \$5 into \$3.90 favouritism and performed accordingly.

Jumping from gate five, Ethan Brown settled Tempted in midfield behind a group of five as second elect Raging Force (Cosmic Force) set a solid pace.

Godolphin's second runner Beiwacht (Bivouac) made a concerted run to take the lead at the 200m, but Tempted swept home down the outside to beat the Chris Waller-trained colt by 1.55 lengths, with Skyhook (Written Tycoon) surging home for third.

Tempted may be prepared by Ciaron Maher these days after Godolphin's switch to public trainers, but the song remained the same in terms of the royal blue army's domination of the Run To The Rose.

Celebrating their quinella, Godolphin have now won the last five runnings of the race, and six of the past seven thanks to James Cummings-trained runners Bivouac (Exceed And Excel) in 2019, and Anamoe (Street Boss), In Secret (I Am Invincible), Cylinder (Exceed And Excel) and Traffic Warden (Street Boss) from 2021-24.

Bookmakers responded by making Tempted a \$3.50 favourite for the main event - the Golden Rose (Gr 1, 1400m) on September 27 - which hasn't been won by a filly since the outstanding Forensics (Flying Spur) in 2008 - the only filly to win it since 2001.

Tempted was also shortened into \$15 for The Everest (Gr 1, 1200m) on October 18. In a market dominated by \$1.70 shot Ka Ying Rising (Shamexpress), Tempted is Godolphin's shortest-priced runner and could be set to fill their slot.

Maher noted three-year-olds had a strong

record in the \$20 million weight-for-age sprint, with two winners in its eight runnings, and with his own colt Growing Empire (Zoustar) running third last year.

Should Tempted line up in the Randwick feature, she would aim to become the second female winner of the race, with Maher's former stable star Bella Nipotina having won the Group 1 last year.

And while conceding the two winners had been males in Yes Yes (Rubick) and Giga Kick (Scissor Kick), Maher said Tempted had the quality to suggest she wouldn't be out of place in the race.

"It probably wouldn't be beyond her," he told Sky Thoroughbred Central. "Three-year-olds have a good [Everest] record. I know the fillies probably haven't done as well as the colts, but she might be one out of the box.

"It's just great to be able to have those conversations. They [Godolphin] are a great team. I've only been dealing with them a short time, but they'll make the right call."

For the nearer term, a different chance at improving recent history seems likely to await with another crack at the three-year-old males in the Golden Rose, which - despite its reputation and importance as a stallion-maker

- is still "only" worth \$1 million in these times of dizzying NSW prize-money.

"I'll have a chat to the team," Maher said.
"She could go a number of different ways, but given how she put them away today, it'd be very attractive."

Maher said he'd been confident of Tempted's chances in the Run To The Rose as she set out to follow a two-year-old season of three wins - two at Group 2 level - from six starts, plus her superb Slipper third and an unlucky seventh in the Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m).

"She's ultimately just very impressive," Maher said of Tempted, who went into Saturday's race off only one barrier trial.

"She was obviously a crack two-year-old, and she developed the right way with the Godolphin team.

"She's a very, very high class filly.

"You can see she doesn't carry a huge amount of weight. She couldn't have been more impressive in her trial on a track that was rain affected at Randwick.

"You can see her coat's just coming on. She's a lovely filly and I'm thrilled.

"I said to Browny this morning when he was on the way to the races, $\,$ Continued on page 4

Brown was equally dazzled with how Tempted scorched past the leaders on a track that had favoured front-runner on the inside.

"When I looked up at the top of the straight, knowing how the track was playing, I thought she'd have to be really good to pick these up - and she was." Brown said. "She really impressed me.

"The race set up well for us, but the track has been quite on-speed, so all credit to her."

Brown said Tempted had answered "the main question" of whether she would measure up to her juvenile season.

"Looking at her last trial you were always confident she was going to," he said. "She's done it on raceday now, so onwards and upwards for her."

Tempted has enhanced a rich Godolphin/ Darley family. She's the fourth foal among five for Calliope (Exceed And Excel), who's also the dam of quadruple stakes winning sprinter Kallos (Medaglia D'Oro).

Calliope herself was a dual black-type winner in a career cut short to just four outings, taking the Gimcrack Stakes (Listed, 1000m) and the Magic Night Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) in 2015-16.

Her latest foal, Zambales (Pinatubo) is a two-year-old in work with Anthony and Sam Freedman, while she was covered by Darley's Anamoe (Street Boss) last spring.

Tempted became the second stakes winner of the new Australian season for Street Boss (Street Cry), and the 12th winner from 49 runners this term for the 22-year-old, who's standing at Darley's Northwood farm in Victoria this season for an unchanged \$66,000 (inc GST).

Beiwacht performed strongly at \$7.50 in his second run for Waller, continuing on from a first-up third in the San Domenico Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m).

Skyhook, at \$5.50, finished well after being blocked for a run in the first half of the straight.

Wootton Bassett's Group 1 placegetters Wodeton and State Visit made solid ground to run fourth and fifth, while Raging Force - chasing a fifth straight win after being a revelation of the winter - weakened into seventh.

Legacy Coolmore Stud Stakes bound after Flemington victory

Exciting gelding Legacy Bound (Ole Kirk) showed he belonged in the top echelon of Australia's three-year-olds and brought up a first black-type success of 2025-26 for last term's champion first season sire Ole Kirk (Written Tycoon) with a stirring victory in Saturday's Poseidon Stakes (Listed, 1100m).

Ahead of Legacy Bound's resumption following 1200-metre wins in his first two starts at Ballarat and in stakes grade in Adelaide, trainer Robbie Griffiths told ANZ News he had one reservation: how the inexperienced Vinery Stud homebred would adapt to his first try up the Flemington straight.

But Legacy Bound handled the often tricky initiation like a veteran, although he ultimately needed all his reserves of courage to score by 0.02 lengths.

Sent out on the fourth line of betting at \$6, and jumping from gate three of eight for Mark Zahra, the hulking Legacy Bound was fast away but took an early sit on the inside just off a comfortable pace.

Just as Legacy Bound took the front-running from Shining Smile (Spirit Of Boom) at the 150m, favourite Tycoon Star (Written Tycoon) and \$26 bolter Navy Pilot (I Am Invincible) also grabbed a share of the lead on the outside.

While the disappointing Tycoon Star fell away to run third at \$2.30, Legacy Bound had to dig deep to repel the challenge of Navy Pilot, but prevailed on the bob of the head.

After winning Morphettville's Breeders' Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) on the gelding at his previous start in April, Zahra had compared him to the colt he'd ridden to victory in the previous year's runner, Growing Empire (Zoustar), who's now covering his first book at Yulong Stud.

Legacy Bound will now likely follow a similar path to that taken by Growing Empire 12 months ago, with hopes high from the stable he can do better than that colt's third in the Coolmore Stud Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) at Flemington on Derby Day.

"I was really cautious today as I said prerace, he'd never been down the straight, and the key runners had had two runs [this time in] each," Griffiths told Racing.com.

"Ironically, the two first-up horses ran onetwo, but he [Legacy Bound] is a good horse.

"He's got room to improve and it gives us a lot of excitement now going into the Danehill Stakes in three weeks, and then the Coolmore.

"One thing about him, he's not the bravest - he likes to follow a mate. $\,$ Continued on page 5

Continued from page 4 He had to have a mate in the pony here today. So when he is in front, he doesn't exert any energy. He's sort of too busy having a look around, so I think that's a real plus for him.

"I'm rapt about today, but I'm looking forward to the Danehill next because now he's had that straight track experience, it's going to help him."

Griffiths said he had opted to concentrate on sprints with Legacy Bound as a campaign towards the Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) would likely have entailed racing on wet tracks in Sydney through a Golden Rose (Gr 1, 1400m) path.

"He hates the wet and he won't prepare well on it," he said. "So, trying to prepare him for the Guineas when the tracks are wet in Sydney, you'd have to run in the Run To The Rose, interstate trip, possibly a wet track like a soft seven today, and go into it third-up.

"So, we thought he's a big horse, he hasn't fully matured. We'll keep it simple, run him in the sprints, and we can stretch him in the autumn."

Zahra was glowing in his praise of Legacy Bound, who was wound in to become an \$8 equal-second favourite for the Coolmore.

"He's got a good will to win," he said. "He's a horse you have to ride very smooth because of his wind. It just worked out nicely. We had to quicken up inside the 400 when they sprinted. It was a fight late but he was up for it and it was a good win.

"He's come on, he'll improve a lot for this run today. It's a handy field he beat today and most of them had runs under their belt so for first-up he's done a good job."

The fourth - and best - foal of another Vinery homebred in the maiden-winning Sanaya (More Than Ready), Legacy Bound was entered for last year's Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale but was withdrawn when complications arose. Vinery then made him the first horse they'd sent to Cranbourne-based Griffiths.

Legacy Bound's second dam Astrodame (Flying Spur) won Moonee Valley's Stocks Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m) alongside six Group placings. And the gelding's fourth dam was the outstanding Midnight Fever (Luskin Star),

winner of the 1987 Blue Diamond, three Group 2s, two Group 3s and a Listed.

Sanaya now has a yearling sister to Legacy Bound, and earlier this month produced a filly by fellow Vinery Stud stallion Exceedance (Exceed And Excel).

Ole Kirk took the debutant sires' title in a season that brought him four stakes winners from just 32 runners at a clip of 12.5 per cent, which prompted Vinery to make him their topranked stallion with a fee rise to \$99,000 (inc GST).

Legacy Bound's Poseidon win gave him seven winners from 20 runners this season, and made him the first second-season sire with a stakes winner for the new term.

The Ciaron Maher-trained Navy Pilot was highly impressive, in his first start since running seventh in Eagle Farm's JJ Atkins (Gr 1, 1600m) in June.

Caulfield Stakes on the table for impressive Vinrock

Burgeoning star Vinrock (I Am Invincible) brought trainer Matt Laurie compensation for a blow to his headline act Treasurethe Moment (Alabama Express) and put forward his Caulfield Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) claims with an imposing second-up stakes win Saturday.

A hero of the autumn through his first three unbeaten starts including the double of the VRC Sires' Produce Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) and ATC Sires' Produce Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m), Vinrock had looked disappointing first-up this campaign when fourth as favourite in Caulfield's McNeil Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m).

But rising 200 metres in Flemington's Exford Plate (Listed, 1400m), and with punters staying firm by backing him into \$2.80 favouritism, Vinrock looked back to his best in scoring his first win for Yulong since they purchased him after the autumn.

Jumping from the widest gate of 11 for Mark Zahra, the three-year-old colt crossed easily and parked menacingly outside the leader Wise Inlaw (Wootton Bassett) under an even tempo. While Wise Inlaw battled hard, Vinrock showed his class by taking over at the 150 metres, and strode away to a 1.75-length win.

West Of Swindon (Wootton Bassett) finished strongly for second at \$8.50 ahead of

\$6.50 shot Wise Inlaw, with that pair providing their Coolmore sire with still two more stakes placings as his wait for his first Australian-born black type winner continued.

Laurie had sobering news during the week in the wake of Treasurethe Moment's slashing first-up win in the Memsie Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m), with the four-year-old suffering a mild bout of colic which put her out of Saturday's Makybe Diva Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m).

The picture brightened a couple of days later, with Laurie announcing the mare would be on target to run second-up in the Feehan Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m) at Moonee Valley on September 26.

Should she line up in the Group 2, the mare will need a new pilot with her regular rider Damian Lane copping a 15-meeting suspension for his ride on Aeliana (Castelvecchio) in the Makybe Diva Stakes.

And Vinrock ended the week on a high for the stable with a win that took his earnings past the \$1m mark, after he was bought by Laurie and Wilannah Park Bloodstock for \$300,000 at Inglis Premier.

"I think he's a pretty tough horse. You put it to him, he tries pretty hard, so I think when the going gets tough he'll give his best," Laurie told Racing.com.

"He's a quality colt, he's by the right stallion. I'm really pleased for Yulong. They've purchased him, he's going to be standing there one day, and it's nice to add to his CV again."

Laurie said while Vinrock wasn't suited by the 1200 metres of the McNeil, the early speed he showed to cross from his wide barrier on Saturday was "one of his assets".

"He can begin well. Obviously over a shorter trip he found it a little bit trickier, but he's a horse that we've always felt would be pretty good over a little bit further," he said.

"It was a good set up today for Mark, and I'm very pleased to see him back in the winner's circle."

Laurie confirmed a return to Sydney for the Golden Rose was likely on Vinrock's agenda.

"I was hoping we'd be going to a Golden Rose third up. I still think we should be looking that path, but we'll have a good chat tomorrow," he said.

Continued from page 5 had "needed the run" first-up and was better suited on a larger track on Saturday.

"He had to come across from the wide barrier and he was a bit keen early, but once he got into his rhythm he was fine," Zahra said.

"The winkers can probably come off now that we know he's trying hard again. I was just able to rest him off the other horse [Wise Inlaw] and he's a horse that needs to be at his top coming into the straight because he can quicken off that. He showed a bit of grit."

Bookmakers responded by tightening Vinrock to \$8 third favouritism for the Caulfield Guineas, behind Autumn Boy (The Autumn Sun) at \$4.00 and Nepotism (Brutal) at \$4.50. Vinrock also shortened for the Golden Rose (Gr 1, 1400m) at Rosehill on September 27, from \$18 to \$11.

Bred by Rosemont Stud, Vinrock is the third and best foal of Girl Gone Rockin' (Redoute's Choice), who won four races including the VRC Matriarch Stakes (Gr 2, 2000m).

Second dam Sorrento (Just A Dancer) won five stakes races across both sides of the Tasman, highlighted by Rosehill's Queen Of The Turf Stakes (Gr 2, 1500m) in 2001 - four years before it became a Group 1.

Girl Gone Rockin' missed to Dundeel (High Chaparral) in 2024, and was covered by Churchill (Galileo) last spring.

Vinrock became I Am Invincible's second stakes winner and 21st overall winner from 110 runners for the new season. One of the Yarraman Park stallion's 121 stakes winners, Vincrock brought up the 266th stakes win for the 21-year-old, who's covering his 16th book this term at \$220,000 (inc GST).



Sir Rupert Clarke plan for Arkansaw Kid

Arkansaw Kid (5 g Harry Angel - Florabella by Exceed And Excel) successfully defended his Bobbie Lewis Quality (Gr 2, 1200m) crown on Saturday and the Lindsay Park team are now considering sending the gelding back to Flemington for the Sir Rupert Clarke Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) next weekend. The five-year-old defeated Star Patrol (Starspangledbanner) by 0.5 lengths with Media World (Written Tycoon) coming home a further 0.8 lengths adrift in third. "We might consider backing him up in the Sir Rupert Clarke," JD Hayes said. "We have never backed him up before and he might be a terrific back-up horse the way that he travels. He might travel that little bit kinder and the little gear change today, the winkers, helped. It got his mind on the job, and he put the race to bed which was good." "We thought he had come of age this preparation and it just hasn't gone to plan in his first two runs this preparation," he said. "He's a horse that is never far away and we've always thought he was a Group 1 horse, especially in a handicap and he proved that today."

Options open for classy Cafe Millenium

Arkansaw Kid's stablemate Cafe Millenium (5 g Not A Single Doubt - Veloce Forte by High Chaparral) scored back-to-back stakes wins when he prevailed under Celine Gaudray in the Tontonan Stakes (Listed, 1400m) at Flemington on Saturday. Last seen taking out the Leon Macdonald Stakes (Listed, 1400m) in Adelaide, the gelding continued on his upward curve with a 0.1-length defeat of Transatlantic (Snitzel). The winner's stable companion Rise At Dawn (Almanzor) finished a further 1.5 lengths away in third. "It was great to see him get his head down, a terrific ride by Celine. She comes in and does a lot of work for us, especially out of Pakenham," said JD Hayes. "For her to be rewarded, I'd like to thank Ron Finnemore [owner] for rewarding her because she got the job done in Adelaide. She's ridden beautifully, and just a terrific result." Having had his grounding in NSW, Hayes was complimentary of the job former trainers John O'Shea and Tom Charlton had done with Cafe Millenium before he joined their stable. "To be honest, he came down a great product. John O'Shea and Tom Charlton did a great job with him, just a little bit of a change in environment, I think he's found his rhythm here," the trainer continued. "He's been very consistent for us, and he's just getting better with age. So that was a terrific win that gave us a big thrill."

64 for So You Think

Coolmore Stud stallion So You Think (High Chaparral) sired his 64th stakes winner on Saturday when Revelare (5 g ex Reveal the Goddess, by Zabeel) took out the Archer Stakes (Gr 3, 2500m) at Flemington. Ridden by Declan Bates for trainer Robert Hickmott, the gelding stayed the trip strongly to defeat Mormona (Morandi) by 0.4 lengths with Sayedaty Sadaty (Anodin) another 1.25 lengths behind in third. Bred by Mrs C Bamford and K.L. Bamford, Revelare was a \$130,000 purchase for Robert Hickmott Racing from Daisy Hill at the 2022 Inglis Premier Yearling Sale. He is the fifth foal and first stakes winner out of 2400 metre winner Reveal The Goddess (Zabeel), who herself is out of New Zealand champion stayer Honor Babe (Honor Grades). So You Think stands at Coolmore in the Hunter Valley for a reduced fee of \$44,000 (inc GST).

Revelare clinches Melbourne Cup berth

Robert Hickmott has sent out two Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) winners courtesy of the Lloyd Williams-owned duo Green Moon (Montjeu) (2021) and Almandin (Monsun) (2016) and Saturday's Archer Stakes winner Revelare will aim to give him and Williams another winner of the Flemington showpiece. With weights due to

Trainer is confident Saturday's win would stand the stayer in good stead for his next assignment in The Bart Cummings (Gr 3, 2500m) at Flemington on October 4. "From the 1600 to his 2000 [metre] run at Caulfield he came on very quickly," Hickmott said. "His coat is probably four weeks away from coming through, he can dapple up quickly, so there's still a lot more to come with him. He'll need to keep that gradual improvement which he's doing but I couldn't be happier with today and Declan's ride again was sensational." Green Moon and Almandin feature among Williams's seven winners of the Melbourne Cup.

Back-to-back stakes wins for Lazzura

Having opened her four-year-old year with a win in the Show County Quality (Gr 3, 1200m) last month, the Chris Waller-trained Lazzura (4 m Snitzel - Laguna Azzurra by Heart's Cry) added a fourth stakes win to her burgeoning CV with a victory in the Let's Elope Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) at Flemington on Saturday. Ridden by James McDonald, the mare beat Oh Too Good (All Too Hard) by 0.2 lengths with another 0.4 lengths back to Abounding (Rich Enuff) in third. A \$500,000 purchase for B2B Thoroughbreds from the draft of her co-breeders Arrowfield at the 2023 edition of the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale, Lazzura is out of the winning Japanese-bred mare Laguna Azzurra (Heart's Cry), making her a half-sister to stakesplaced winner Portorosa (Not A Single Doubt).

Group 1 plan for Lazzura

Following Lazzura's victory in the Let's Elope Stakes, Chris Waller said the mare will be aimed at Group 1s this preparation, but no concrete decision has been made. "She's tough," said Waller. "She puts herself in the race, James gave her a lovely ride. She gave a good kick at the 300 metre mark. It got close, but she's tough. She was good over the concluding stages. She's building a good resume. [We're] very open minded. She's still in the mix for an Epsom, also a Toorak, then you've got the Golden Eagle as well, and obviously Group 1s you want to put on the CV as well. The mile will certainly suit, so it's a good problem to have and there's a lot to think about."

Big spring in the offing for My Gladiola

John McArdle's talented filly My Gladiola (I Am Invincible) returned to winning form with a determined victory in the Cap D'Antibes Stakes (Listed, 1100m) at Flemington on Saturday. Ridden by her regular partner Jamie Mott, the filly surged late and held off her rivals to score by 0.15 lengths over Akaysha (Capitalist). McArdle said the run would bring his filly on significantly in fitness. "She is a little bit like her trainer, she carries a bit of condition and still did today. Got a bit wound up when she first got here, she's never been here before." Reflecting on the race itself, McArdle added: "Probably got a bit looky when she hit the front. Just early, from the bad gate she didn't find the cover that we wanted. She switches off when she finds cover, but she did pull pretty hard. So there's good improvement in her. But Jamie knows her brilliantly and he just let her build into the race, probably got a bit lost when she got to the front but she's a very well-bred filly. Kia Ora Stud, great supporters, and Paul Johnson and the other owners. So, great to get a win for them." Looking ahead, McArdle is confident My Gladiola will stretch out in distance. "I think she will. I think maybe in the autumn she'll be a 1400-metre horse. But at the moment, myself, Luke Wilkinson from Kia Ora, Paul Johnson and Brent Clayton all sat down and worked out a plan with her and so far, so good. She was unlucky in the Ouezette. She's won here today, so the plan will be to take the colts on in the Danehill. That's why she came here, to get a look down the straight, and then if she acquits herself well enough against the colts, we'll head to the Coolmore."

New Zealand-bred gelding Golden Path (Belardo) staked his claim for higher honours later in the spring with a strong-finishing victory to close out Saturday's Flemington card. The Mick Price and Michael Kent Jnr-trained sixyear-old was second-up in the \$150,000 Ronald McDonald House Charities Trophy (1700m), having resumed with a third over 1600 metres at Caulfield on August 16. Golden Path ran home strongly to beat Kingswood (Roaring Lion) by 0.4 lengths with Young Werther (Tavistock) a close-up third. "It was a brutally run race," winning rider Blake Shinn said. "I got into a good spot. Globe really made us earn the win, carrying the

Trained by Chris Waller and ridden by Rachel King, the colt led the field and extended away to defeat the fast-finishing Autumn Boy (The Autumn Sun) by 0.56 lengths, with Without Peer (Pierata) a further 2.68 lengths behind in third. Bred by Mr GJ Perry, the colt was a \$350,000 purchase for Aramco Racing from Vinery Stud's 2024 Inglis Easter Yearling Sale draft. He is the sixth foal out of unraced mare Gracie's Lass (Redoute's Choice), who has also produced Group 1 winner and now Newgate Farm sire Artorious (Flying Artie). The family also includes elitelevel winner Delectation (Shamardal). Flying Artie stands at Blue Gum Farm in Euroa for \$11,000 (inc GST).

Blinkers do the trick for Nkosi

Darby Racing's new recruit Nkosi (Shamus Award) collected his second win from three Australian starts with a dominant front-running performance in a 1800-metre handicap at Rosehill on Saturday. "Going up in trip and the blinkers going on helped him a little bit," Baker said. "His last start was a bit of a sprint home, which probably didn't suit him." Joliestar will now line up in next week's The Shorts (Gr 2, 1100m) at Randwick instead.

Lane to miss Treasurethe Moment ride

Damian Lane will miss the ride on Treasurethe Moment (Alabama Express) should the mare head to the Feehan Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m) on Manikato Stakes night a week on Friday after copping a 15-meeting suspension for his ride on Aeliana (Castelvecchio) in the Makybe Diva Stakes on Saturday. The jockey pleaded guilty to using the whip five more times than permitted before the 100-metre mark in the day's feature at Flemington, which was controlled and won by Mr Brightside (Bullbars). Lane will begin his suspension on September 21 and can resume riding on October 4, which is Turnbull Stakes Day. He was also fined \$3,000 for the breach. The suspension means Laurie will have to find a replacement rider if Treasurethe Moment heads to the Feehan Stakes, a plan that was mooted earlier this week after the star mare's colic scare, though it was far from a firm commitment. "I'd be suggesting maybe the Feehan at The Valley over a mile and then work it out from there," Matt Laurie told Michael Felgate on Tuesday's The Verdict podcast. "We don't want to get too ahead of ourselves."

Glow (4 m The Autumn Sun Via Africa by Var) moved her
unbeaten record to six when
she produced an impressive performance to

Ridden by Kerrin McEvoy, the \$1.8 million Easter purchase never looked in any danger of surrendering her perfect record, eventually crossing the line 2.2 lengths ahead of General Salute (Russian Revolution). Pier (Proisir) came home a further 1.7 lengths away in third.

While the Epsom Handicap (Gr 1, 1600m) at Randwick on October 4 remains the mare's main target, Waller's assistant trainer Charlie Duckworth said the handicapper's assessment would ultimately determine if she pressed on to that Group 1 or not.

"She's got to be the best horse in training who is yet to win a Group 1, which is the one thing that's missing off her resume, but I'm sure that will come," Duckworth said.

"The target was the Epsom so it will be interesting to see what weight she gets in that.

"She is still very lightly raced and continuing to improve. What her optimum distance is, is yet to be seen. She has got endless gears.

"She must have almost given Kerrin a fright how quickly she quickened up around the home turn. She is just electric.

"I don't think he even asked her, I think he might have just been thinking about asking her and then she took off."

When asked whether he thought Autumn Glow would be better suited to the mile of an Epsom Handicap or brought back in distance for The Everest, McEvoy was convinced she could do either.

"I think she'll stay further but she's got a motor as well," McEvoy said.

"I'm sure Chris and the team will make the right call. Probably a mile because then I might be in with a chance to ride her."

Silverdale and Shrone Bloodstock purchased Autumn Glow from her breeders Newhaven at the Magic Millions Gold Coast Weanling Sale for \$600,000 in 2022, before selling her to co-owners Arrowfield Pastoral and Hermitage Thoroughbreds for a sale-topping \$1.8 million the following year.

Silverdale's Steve Grant said: "She was enormous, she's very special and she's only going to get better and better, that's the best part.

"She's such a professional and always has been. We've got a photo of her here after we got her to the farm and you could tell straight away she's a thinker, such a kind and settled filly, even back then. If you go back to one of the Inglis videos either before or just after she sold at Easter, Rob [Petith] said she's the most special horse he'd ever taken to a sale.

"I'm so happy for John Messara and the Arrowfield team and Hermitage, from our point of view we're there to sell and it's great to see people doing well with them, that's what we want."

She defeated Bona Sforza (Written By) by 1.8 lengths with Intention (Bivouac) a further 0.2 lengths behind in third. Bred and raced by her trainers, the filly is out of five-time winner Firelight (Fantastic Light), whose five other winners are headed by the Group 3-placed Fire Show (Showcasing). The family also includes Tavistock (Montjeu) and Precedence (Zabeel).

War Of Silence makes winning debut at Riccarton

War Of Silence (Snitzel) made the perfect start to his career when he landed a 1200-metre maiden at Riccarton on Saturday. A well supported \$3.00 favourite, the Te Akau-owned colt jumped cleanly and travelled on speed for Opie Bosson before lengthening at the 300 metres and finding enough late to win by 0.2 lengths. "It was a good debut win, especially because it's never easy having your first start down the chute at Riccarton, after going around a bend in his trials," said Mark Walker, who trains in partnership with Sam Bergerson. "He looked vulnerable when challenged hard over the last 100 metres, but he really knuckled down and we know how hard Opie is to beat in a tight finish. I do think he'll be better next start, when he's going 1400 metres, around a bend, and he'll most likely head towards the Guineas Trial for three-year-olds on September 27 at Riccarton. He's certainly a nice colt, has the best nature, and a lovely laidback sort of fellow." Bergerson added: "I think he'll learn a lot from that and Opie gave him a good, positive ride. He got a bit keen early, but then settled nicely, probably gawked a bit when in front and when the horse came up and challenged, he really kicked. He looks a really nice colt that we can hopefully get to the 2000 Guineas. It's step one

Miss Starlight holds a nomination for the New Zealand 1000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) at Riccarton on 8 November with TAB Bookmakers establishing her as the \$10 Fixed Odds third favourite behind Lollapalooza (El Roca) and Tajana (Darci Brahma).

Bred by Karen Parsons out of her five-race winner Firelight, Miss Starlight is closely related to the ill-fated multiple Group 1 winner Tavistock who was establishing himself as a world class stallion at Cambridge Stud before his untimely death in 2019.

Forsman is keen to get a run under their belts for as many of the five-strong team he has nominated on the day but is mindful he doesn't want to hinder their spring campaign preparations with a gut-busting run on a very testing track. "You normally get a really good track to run on here at Te Rapa despite the weather, but with the rain we have had and the impending forecast I'm just not sure how many of mine will actually line-up on the day," Forsman said. "I will wait until tomorrow [Sunday] morning to make that call but if it looks like being a true Heavy10 then we might only have one of our five on deck." Forsman was referring to impressive last start maiden winner Fat Cat (Written Tycoon) who will take his place in race seven on the program. "He [Fat Cat] has a run under his belt and does handle it fairly wet so he will most likely run," he said. "He is still early in his prep and carrying plenty of condition so he needs some racing to get him ready for the plans we have for him. Our aim at this stage is to run in the Hawke's Bay Guineas here in a fortnight so he needs to start."

Four for Satono Diamond

Satono Diamond (Deep Impact) sired his fourth stakes winner when the Tomokazu Takano-trained Allnatt (4 c ex Cutie Gold by French Deputy) landed the The Challenge Cup (Gr 3, 2000m) at Hanshin on Saturday. The four-year-old colt defeated Grande Venus (Kitasan Black) by a length with Meiner Chrysola (Screen Hero) a further neck back in third. Out of the placed mare Cutie Gold (French Deputy), Allnatt is a three-quarter brother to Shonan Pandora (Deep Impact), whose two Grade 1s were headed by a victory in the Japan Cup (Gr 1, 2400m) in 2015.

UK: Scandinavia scores thrilling St Leger win

Justify (Scat Daddy) sired his second Classic winner of the season when Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) entrant Scandinavia (3 c Justify - Fabulous by Galileo) showed tenacity in spades to win the St Leger Stakes (Gr 1, 1m 6.5f) at Doncaster on Saturday, providing his trainer Aidan O'Brien a ninth win in the Group 1.

An impressive winner of the Bahrain Trophy Stakes (Gr 3, 1m 5f) in July, the colt followed up that win with a Group 1 breakthrough in the Goodwood Cup (Gr 1, 2m) later on that month.

Ridden by Tom Marquand on Saturday, the colt had no issues with the drop back in trip, finishing strongly to beat the rallying Rahiebb (Frankel) by a neck. The winner's stablemate Stay True (Galileo) came home a further length away in third.

O'Brien, winning the race for the third year running, watched on from day one of the Irish Champions Festival at Leopardstown and shared his delight after the race.

"He's hardy and Tom gave him a great ride," said O'Brien. "He stays very well but were a little bit worried when the ground got on the softer side. He's a lovely horse. He's a typical Justify, he's very, very genuine. The better the ground, the better you'll see from him and I'd say there's plenty to come from him.

"Scandinavia is in the Melbourne Cup. It's a possibility. He'll have to go and get scanned and see whether he is eligible to go or not, but there's a very good chance the lads might want to go down there with him."

Marquand was winning a second Leger after scoring on Galileo Chrome (Australia) in 2020 and he said it was a straightforward race.

"He's got the most beautiful temperament. Speaking to Aidan O'Brien, Ryan Moore and Wayne Lordan, the thing they all said was just how straightforward he was," he said.

"The ground is hard work and they all

came to have a go at him, but he covered them all. To be aboard for Ballydoyle is something special."

Marquand, who rode the winner as a maiden last year, said he could see the potential then but never envisaged winning the Leger on him.

He added: "I thought he'd be a lovely staying type but I managed to get beat on him that day. He's an extremely special horse and one I'm privileged to be sat aboard today."

Raced by Michael Tabor, Derrick Smith and John Magnier, Scandinavia is a half-brother to fellow Group 1 scorer Above The Curve (American Pharoah) being out of the unraced Galileo (Sadler's Wells) mare Fabulous, herself a half-sister Group 1 winner turned sire Giant's Causeway (Storm Cat).

Being out of a Galileo mare, Scandinavia is bred on the same cross as eight other stakes winners including multiple Group 1 winner City Of Troy, who will cover his first book of mares at Coolmore's Jerry Plains base this spring.

Justify, who shuttled to Coolmore Australia between 2019-2021 and again in 2023, enjoyed Classic glory earlier in the season when the Charlie Appleby-trained Ruling Court landed the 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1m) at Newmarket. Sadly, it was announced last month the Godolphin-owned colt had to be put down following complications arising from the hoof disease laminitis.

The Triple Crown winner stood the 2025 northern hemisphere breeding season at Coolmore's Ashford Stud for a fee of US\$250,000 (approx. AU\$384,720).

14 for St Mark's Basilica

Coolmore's first-season stallion St Mark's Basilica (Siyouni) continued his hot-run of form when he scored his 14th individual winner after the Ed Dunlop-trained Pathein (2 c ex Excellent View by Shamardal) made a winning debut at Doncaster on Saturday. The juvenile stayed on bravely to beat Lyneham (Wootton Bassett) by a head, while De Maro (Camelot) finished another four and a half lengths away in third. Bred by Lady Bamford and The Hon Alice Bamford, the colt was sold through their Daylesford Stud draft at Book 2 of the Tattersalls October Yearling Sale last year and was purchased by Highflyer and his trainer for 150,000gns. He is out of the placed Excellent View (Shamardal) making him half-brother Listed scorer Mutaraffa (Acclamation). St Mark's Basilica has returned to Coolmore Australia for the 2025 season and is standing for an unchanged fee of \$38,500 (inc GST).

IRE: Delacroix back in the big time with Irish Champion triumph

The Aidan O'Brien-trained Delacroix (3 c Dubawi - Tepin by Bernstein) bounced back from his last-start Juddmonte International (Gr 1, 1m 2.5f) defeat with an ultra impressive victory in the Irish Champion Stakes (Gr 1, 1m 2f) at Leopardstown on Saturday. Ridden by Christophe Soumillon, the son of Dubawi (Dubai Millennium) showed his customary turn of foot to beat Anmaat (Awtaad) by threequarters of a length with another two and a quarter lengths back to Royal Champion (Shamardal). It was a second Group 1 for the colt, who broke through at the top level in the Coral-Eclipse (Gr 1, 1m 2f) at Sandown in July. "He is very important for us," said co-owner Michael Tabor. "I don't know where we go with him next, I haven't sat down and spoken to Derek [Smith] and John [Magnier] about it. This is a special horse and we will just enjoy today. He has a fantastic turn of foot and everything you want in a stallion; he has performed on the track, he has the conformation and the pedigree. He is utopia."

IRE: Fallen Angel flies to Matron Stakes victory

The Karl Burke-trained Fallen Angel (4 f Too Darn Hot - Agnes Stewart by Lawman) added a fourth top-flight win to her glittering CV when she took out the Matron Stakes (Gr 1, 1m) at Leopardstown on Saturday. Ridden by James Doyle, the Wathnan-owned filly beat Exactly (Frankel) by half a length with another three-quarters of a length back to Atsila (Phoenix Of Spain) in third. "She will be kept in training next year and could go for the Sun Chariot next, I know the only time she hasn't really performed was on the Rowley Mile but I don't think that was anything to do with the course," said Burke.

71 for Wootton Bassett

Coolmore's star shuttler Wootton Bassett (Iffraaj) sired his 71st individual stakes winner when his front-running son Puerto Rico (2 c ex April Showers by Galileo) broke his maiden at the sixth attempt in the Champagne Stakes (Gr 2, 7f) at Doncaster on Saturday. Ridden by Sean Levey and trained by Aidan O'Brien, the colt found more in the driving rain to beat Oxagon (Frankel) by a length. Cape Ortaor (Mohaather) finished a further length and three quarters away in third. Puerto Rico is out of the Listedplaced winner April Showers, herself a sister to multiple Group 1 winner Misty For Me, the dam of top-flight-winning pair Roly Poly (War Front) and US Navy Flag (War Front) and Grade 3 scorer Cover Song (Fastnet Rock). Puerto Rico is out of the Listed-placed winner April Showers is also a sister Prix Marcel Boussac (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Ballydoyle, who in turn produced stakes-winning Red Riding Hood (Justify) and Monday (Fastnet Rock). In winning the Group 2, Puerto Rico became the ninth stakes winner bred on the Wootton Bassett / Galileo (Sadler's Wells) cross. Wootton Bassett is standing at Coolmore Australia for a record-breaking fee of \$385,000 (inc GST).

Three for St Mark's Basilica

St Mark's Basilica (Siyouni), another Coolmore Stud shuttler, scored his third individual stakes winner on Saturday when Puerto Rico's stablemate Diamond Necklace (2 f ex Prudenzia by Dansili) scored an impressive victory in the Ingabelle Stakes (Listed, 7f) at Leopardstown.

Ridden by Christophe Soumillon for Aidan O'Brien, the filly pulled effortlessly clear in the closing stages to beat Sukanya (Havana Grey) by two and a quarter lengths. Caught U Sleeping (Cotai Glory) came home in third, another half a length away. Diamond Necklace was purchased by MV Magnier for €1.7 million at the 2024 Arqana Deauville August Yearling Sale and runs in the silks of Michael Tabor, Derrick Smith, John Magnier and Westerberg. Superbly bred, she is a half-sister to eight winners including 2019 Mackinnon Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) heroine Magic Wand (Galileo) and Irish Oaks (Gr 1, 1m 4f) winner Chicquita (Montjeu), being out of the Listed-winning Dansili (Danehill) mare Prudenzia. Prudenzia enjoyed another brilliant result in the sales ring this year when her Night Of Thunder (Dubawi) filly sold to Amo Racing for an auction record price of €3,000,000 at the Arqana August Yearling Sale. O'Brien said the filly could now head to the Fillies' Mile (Gr 1, 1m) at Newmarket or the Prix Marcel-Boussac (Gr 1, 1600m) on Arc day next month. Last year's Arqana August sale-topper is the second stakes winner in 48 hours for the multiple Group 1-winning son of Siyouni (Pivotal) following the victory of Aylin in the May Hill Stakes (Gr 2, 1m) at Doncaster on Thursday.

168 for Frankel

Well-bred Benvenuto Cellini (2 c ex Newspaperofrecord by Lope De Vega) produced a dominant display to win the Champions Juvenile Stakes (Gr 2, 1m) at Leopardstown on Saturday and in the process became the 168th individual stakes winner for the Juddmonte-based sire Frankel (Galileo). Trained by Aidan O'Brien, the colt scampered away to beat Hardy Warrior (Pinatubo) by five lengths with another half a length back to Nil Bua Gan Dua (American Pharoah) in third. Bred by Coolmore and White Birch Farm, who remain in ownership, Benvenuto Cellini is out of the dual US Grade 1 winner Newspaperofrecord (Lope De Vega), making him a brother to Giselle, winner of this season's Oaks Trial Fillies' Stakes (Listed, 1m 3.5f), who then finished fifth in the English Oaks (Gr 1, 1m4f). Newspaperofrecord is out of Group 3 scorer Sunday Times (Holy

Roman Emperor), who is also the dam of Classical Times (Lawman). "He is a lovely horse and has a big open stride," O'Brien commented. He can go again this year, maybe the Racing Post [Futurity Trophy Stakes] or one of the French races and then start in the Derby trials next year, I'd imagine." Following the victory, Benvenuto Cellini was propelled into favouritism for next year's Derby (Gr 1, 1m 4f) at Epsom.

154 for Invincible Spirit

Pensioned sire Invincible Spirit (Green Desert) was handed his 154th individual stakes winner when the Andrew Balding-trained Marvelman (3 c ex Varamini by Siyouni) landed the Park Stakes (Gr 2, 7f) at Doncaster on Saturday. Raced by the Gorrells, who are based in

Australia, the colt pulled impressively clear to beat King's Gamble (Kingman) by three and three-quarter lengths with another nose back to Audience (Iffraaj) in third. Purchased by his trainer for 140,000gns at Book 1 of the Tattersalls October Yearling Sale, the colt is out of the placed mare Varamini (Siyouni), a half-sister to Group-winning pair Volta (Siyouni) and Calvados Blues (Lando). Having stood at the Irish National Stud, Invincible Spirit was retired from stallion duties last year at the age of 27.

Four for Fascinating Rock

Burgage Stud-based Fascinating Rock, a son of the late Fastnet Rock (Danehill), chalked up his fourth individual stakes winner when the Karl Burke-trained Convergent (3 c ex Monty's Miracle by Shamardal) landed the CMG Group Stakes (Gr 3, 1m 4f) at Leopardstown on Saturday. The three-year-old defeated Fleetfoot (Teofilo) by a length and a half with Sons And Lovers (Study Of Man) another half a length

away in third. Convergent is out of Monty's Miracle (Shamardal), making him a brother to Group 3 winner Molten Rock. Monty's Miracle is a half-sister to the Group 3-placed winner Dark Crusader (Cape Cross), the dam of Caulfield Cup (Gr 1, 2400m) winner Duke De Sessa (Lope De Vega).

Comanche Brave (Wootton Bassett) came home a further nose away in third. Alakazi is out of Alaiya, an unplaced daughter of Sea The Stars and Group 3 scorer Alanza (Dubai Destination).
