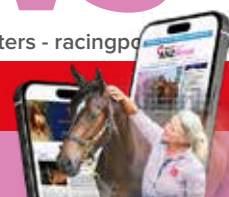

REJECTED!

*APC blocks more than 40 proposed upgrades
throughout Australia, along with four NSW Group 1s*

Racing Australia (RA) will go back to the drawing board this week after a bid to make four more NSW races Group 1s - and upgrade more than 40 other events around the country without making downgrades - was rejected by the Asian Racing Federation's Asian Pattern Committee (APC).

Australia's black type impasse continues as the move for a vast suite of upgrades was rejected at last Thursday's meeting of the APC.

ANZ News understands that following a push by Racing NSW, a proposal was put to the APC to upgrade four Randwick races to Group 1 level.

This would have encompassed adding the \$10 million Golden Eagle (1500m) and the \$3m Russell Balding Stakes (1300m) to the black type pattern on the top rung, while also upgrading key Everest (Gr 1, 1200m) lead-up the Premier Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) and the autumn's Apollo Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) - races currently worth \$1 million and \$300,000 respectively.

Notable Speech shines in Woodbine Mile

Last year's English 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1m) winner Notable Speech (4 c ex Dubawi - Swift Rose by Invincible Spirit) gained a first success this season when delivering a flashing late run to land the Woodbine Mile Stakes (Gr 1, 8f) at Woodbine on Saturday.

The four-year-old had not won since the Sussex Stakes (Gr 1, 1m) last July and was most recently denied by a head in the Jacques le Marois (Gr 1, 1600m), but he made the trip to Toronto well worth the effort when storming home under William Buick to land the Grade 1 contest.

Continued from page 2 But ANZ News also understands RA went to the APC seeking approval for upgrades to more than 40 other races across the country. These did not include any mooted new Group 1s.

All proposed upgrades were rejected by the APC on the grounds Australia does not have a proper black type committee to decide on the status of races, and does not operate under an APC-approved system of ground rules for determining the pattern, ANZ understands.

Lengthy debate on Australia's broken black type situation, and on possible ways to resolve it, ensued at the meeting.

RA attended the Zoom conference after its scheduled board meeting late last month

- which would have aimed to achieve a resolution to Australia's black type shambles - was cancelled at the last minute, due to a realisation agreement between the states was highly unlikely.

Late last year, the national body put forward a new system of black type guidelines to address both the fact Australia has not had a pattern committee since 2018, and legal advice that because of the country's federated state system, traditional ways of determining the pattern across the country could run counter to anti-competition laws.

Those guidelines would be based mainly on race ratings - ranking proponents of a traditional black type committee with discretionary powers to determine black type status bearing in mind other factors. These would include the cultural and historical significance of races, helping, for example, to ensure smaller states preserved their number of black type events, especially Group 1s.

Such matters had been expected to be

addressed at RA's board meeting before it was cancelled.

It's believed the new and vast list of 40-plus races slated for upgrades had been determined on ratings alone. The fact they were spread around the country might at least suggest there has been dialogue between the states, after years of tension.

Continued from page 3 a functioning pattern committee, another sticking point was the list of proposed upgrades was put forward without acknowledgement of the need for downgrades.

Australia has had no races downgraded for some 13 years.

Australia now has 608 black type races, up from 549 in 2000. The proposals tabled at the APC meeting would have pushed the number past 650 - a figure which critics charge, in the continuing absence of downgrades, dilutes the Australian black type product, and erodes its significance.

ANZ News understands the RA proposals were not killed off completely at the APC meeting, but were rejected pending the presentation of more information about how Australia intends to determine its black type races.

They are, however, considered long odds of being approved - unless Australia radically overhauls its current black type situation, addressing the APC's concerns.

Meanwhile, the status of the 18 NSW races run under supposed upgrades since the start of last season remain unapproved by the APC - meaning those "upgrades" are not reflected in sales catalogues.

Amid much confusion, RNSW and RA continue to advertise the 18 under their unapproved new gradings. The next one of these comes up on October 11 with the Tapp-

Craig (1400m), which was "upgraded" from non-black type to Listed.

After that comes three in one day - Everest day on October 18 - with faux Group 3s in the Reginald Allen Quality (1400m), the ATC St Leger (2600m) and the Silver Eagle (1300m). The latter two supposedly entered the pattern as Group 3s, while the Reginald Allen was "upgraded" from Listed.

Australian Bloodstock's Al Riffa cut for Melbourne Cup as he proves a class apart in Irish St Leger romp

Australian Bloodstock have a knack of buying high-class European imports and they look to have another brilliant one on their hands in the shape of the Joseph O'Brien-trained Al Riffa (Wootton Bassett), who advertised his Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) potential with an ultra-dominant performance in the Irish St Leger (Gr 1, 1m 6f) at the Curragh on Sunday.

Australian Bloodstock purchased the dual Group 1-winning son of Coolmore's star shuttler Wootton Bassett (Ifraaj) at the end of last month with the Flemington showpiece on the first Tuesday in November in mind and he more than justified their faith with an imperious display in the final Classic of the European season.

Winning rider Dylan Browne McMonagle was recording his first Classic win with this success, and his mount moved powerfully through the pack from off the pace before sprinting four lengths clear of King Edward VII Stakes (Gr 2, 1m 4f) winner Amiloc (Postponed) to end the three-year-old's unbeaten run.

Al Qareem (Awtaad) was third, another four and a quarter lengths off the pace.

Bookmakers in Europe responded by slashing Al Riffa's price for the Melbourne Cup from 6-1 favourite (\$7) from 12-1 (\$13).

O'Brien said: "We knew the guys that were guaranteed stayers were going to try to expose the stamina of those that weren't, and the pace was really strong.

"Dylan was cool on the horse and confident. He's been a great horse for us, he always turns up and runs his race and I'm delighted for the ownership group.

"It was a gruelling race, but we'll freshen him up and hopefully get him to the Melbourne Cup.

"He's two for two now since he's gone up in trip and he has the right attributes. He

settles well, he has a turn of foot, and he stays. Hopefully we have a smooth preparation."

Lovett added: "He was perfectly prepared by Joseph and his team, and we're delighted to be a part of it.

"He wasn't a hard horse to identify when he went out to 2800 metres last time. That convinced us that he might be the horse to try to win the Melbourne Cup.

"He'll need to carry weight because they won't miss him, but I feel sure he's the right horse to do that.

"Joseph knows how to win the race, and we have four Melbourne Cups between us."

Australian Bloodstock have a proven track record with northern hemisphere imports, highlighted by their 2022 Melbourne Cup triumph with fellow French-bred Gold Trip (Outstrip), while they tasted success in the Flemington showpiece for the first time in 2014 with Protectionist (Monsun), who was bred in Germany.

This year Australian Bloodstock will likely also be represented in the race by last year's favourite Vauban (Galiway), who they purchased last year and relocated him from Willie Mullins to Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott.

Jamie Lovett, director of Australian Bloodstock, confirmed to ANZ News last month that the horse will stay in training with O'Brien and, while the Melbourne Cup is the entire's main aim, he could also venture on an international campaign which could include both Dubai and Hong Kong.

Before Sunday, Al Riffa had tasted elite-level success on two previous occasions, his first coming in the National Stakes (Gr 1, 7f) as a two-year-old, while he also took out last year's Grosser Preis von Berlin (Gr 1, 2400m) in Germany.

Bred by Sarl De Chambure Haras D'Etreham Et Al in France, Al Riffa is the third foal out of the unraced Galileo (Sadler's Wells) mare Love On My Mind, herself a sister to Group 3 winner and Ascot Gold Cup (Gr 1, 2m 4f) second Mizzou.

Like the owners, O'Brien will be aiming to win the Melbourne Cup for a third time, having won it first with Rekindling (High Chaparral) in 2017, before Twilight Payment (Teofilo) handed the trainer a second victory in the Group 1 in 2020.

Al Riffa is still entire so could follow in the footsteps of Gold Trip who now stands at Lovatsville in Victoria for a fee of \$8,800 (inc GST).

Strong Underwood representation for Waller

Chris Waller could have an army of runners in Saturday's Underwood Stakes (Gr 1, 1800m) at Caulfield as he chases back-to-back wins in the Group 1 contest. Buckaroo (Fastnet Rock), last year's winner, will be back to defend his title over 1800 metres and will be joined by his stablemates Anisette (Awtaad) and Moira (Ghostzapper), while Land Legend (Galileo) and River Of Stars (Sea The Stars) are also potential starters. Waller was delighted with the first-up performance of Buckaroo in the Memsie Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Caulfield on August 30 when third behind Treasurethe Moment. "It was an awesome return," Waller said. "We were left wondering where he was after the autumn. Maybe he is a much better horse in the spring as his autumn form the year before wasn't much better. He's had a trial and the 1800 metres of the Underwood should suit him perfectly, but I would have liked to have been third-up in the race. He's not, so he had

a trial on Friday morning which gave him a day out and he's ready to go."

Jedibeel reroutes to Shorts after setback

Running Jedibeel (Savabeel) first-up in The Shorts (Gr 2, 1100m) at Randwick on Saturday had never been Plan A for trainer Brad Widdup but after missing a scheduled start in the Concorde Stakes (Gr 2, 1000m) due to a setback, he is resigned to pitting his charge against some of the country's best sprinters. A key lead-up race to The Everest (Gr 1, 1200m) on October 18, The Shorts is also being targeted by T J Smith Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Briasa (Smart Missile), who has been trialling superbly, along with the likes of Joliestar (Zoustar), Private Harry (Harry Angel) and Headwall (Dream Ahead). Jedibeel was scratched from the Concorde Stakes last week due to a light ankle strain and Widdup felt next weekend's The Shorts shaped as an even stiffer target. "Very hard race," Widdup said. "That is why it was very frustrating not to be able to run him last week. I'm not saying he would have won that race, but he drew well and it looked a good race for him. This race is going to be ten times harder. We are under no illusions there but we have to kick him off somewhere and I'd rather stay at home in Sydney, get him going and then we can work it out from there."

Private Eye heads to the 7 Stakes

The Joe Pride-trained Private Eye (Al Maher)

will head to the 7 Stakes (1600m) at Randwick on Saturday, where he will likely be joined in the \$1 million race by his stablemate Ceolwulf (Tavistock). Private Eye won the PB Lawrence Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) first-up and was last seen finishing second behind Pericles (Street Boss) in the Tramway Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) on September 6. Ceolwulf, meanwhile, finished fourth in the Winx Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) on his seasonal debut and most recently occupied that same placing in the Chelmsford Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m).

Treasurethe Moment confirmed for Feehan

Matt Laurie has confirmed his star mare Treasurethe Moment (Alabama Express) will head to the Feehan Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m) at The Valley on September 26. The Group 2 was provisionally placed on the mare's agenda after she had a mild attack of colic following her impressive first-up victory in the Memsie Stakes, which ruled her out of last Saturday's Makybe Diva Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m). "She had a trot and canter yesterday [Friday] and today she seems really bright," Laurie told Racing.com. "I think the Feehan is a really nice race regardless and it will give us a bit of an insight as to how she handles that track. It's really the only option. I think she can get there. It's two weeks away and she really didn't lose too much work and she's so clean-winded. It was a bit of a scare. She had a build-up of gas in her intestine. It was very uncomfortable and left unattended. Those things can be lethal, but it came good



pretty quickly with some good assistance. There are varying types of colic and it was on the lower scale, but it was enough to knock her around. You don't want it to happen to any horse let alone Treasurethe Moment." The team will now be tasked with finding the multiple Group 1 winner a new rider after Damian Lane was outed for 13 meetings for overuse of the whip on Aeliana (Castelvecchio) in the Makybe Diva Stakes.

Manikato plan for Skybird

After a luckless run in the Moir Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m) at The Valley earlier this month, the Mitch Freedman-trained Skybird (Exosphere) will return to the Melbourne track for the Manikato Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) a week on Friday. Last season's Black Caviar Lightning Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m) winner will head to the Group following her sixth-placed finish behind Baraqiel (Snitzel) in the 1000-metre sprint at the same venue and, while there has been some chat around the Everest for the mare, Freedman is focusing on the Manikato. "She's pulled up really good," Freedman told Racing.com. "We're fully focused on the Manikato at this stage. Those [Everest] slot-holders who haven't got a horse yet are probably just waiting to see how things play out. Either way, you couldn't have been more impressed with Ka Ying Rising winning on Sunday night and whatever ends up in The Everest is going to have a hard time beating him, that's for sure."

Savvy Hallie spelled

Meanwhile, Brad Widdup also confirmed Jedibeel's Silver Shadow Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m)-winning stablemate Savvy Hallie (Hellbent) would not be seen again this spring following her third-placed finish in the Furious Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m). "She has gone for a break," Widdup said. "Everything is fine. She is going to be better as she gets on."

New Zealand

Agera aces open-class test

Improving six-year-old Agera (Complacent) had no issues being stepped into open company for the first time in Sunday's Vision Complete Earthworks/Stronger Together (1600m) at Te

Rapa, coming away with a 2.3-length win over Aftermath (Rock 'N' Pop). The \$50,000 race was the third win from four starts in the 2025-26 season for Agera. The gelding scored back-to-back wins on the Cambridge synthetic track in August, then carried 62kg into a close sixth in a Rating 75 (1600m) on Proisir Plate Day at Ellerslie last Saturday. Cambridge trainer Tony Pike backed Agera up eight days later at Te Rapa, rising in class while dropping sharply in weight to 54kg. "It was good to see him step up into open company today and continue the good form that he'd been putting together in the lower grades," Pike said. "I thought it was a brave effort last week under his big weight at Ellerslie. Dropping to 54kg today made a massive difference and the rain-affected ground seemed to suit him well. He hasn't been the soundest horse at times in his career, but now that he's getting a bit older, he's developed into a stronger and more mature horse and has found a real purple patch of form in this campaign. He does need that bit of cut in the ground, so if the tracks continue to be rain-affected for a few more weeks, a race like the Matamata Cup could be a nice target for him to aim at." The \$80,000 Team Wealleans Matamata Cup (Listed, 1600m) will be run on October 4.

Group test looms for Midnight Edition

The Spring Sprint (Gr 3, 1400m) at Otaki on October 11 could be the next assignment for the Bruce Wallbank-trained Midnight Edition (Wrote) following his victory in an open company event over 1200 metres at Te Rapa on Sunday. The four-year-old gelding defeated Twain (Per Incanto) by an impressive 3.3 lengths, while the winner's half-sister, Midnight Scandal (Belardo), came home a further 2.3

lengths adrift in third. "He's a bloody good horse," Wallbank said. "He had a very good spell and I thought he was a bit fat coming into this race and would probably need the run. But he's been galloping brilliantly and he's shown that he's a very good horse. We'll probably head towards the big sprint race at Otaki next month. In the meantime, I'd like to dedicate this race to my brother, who's very unwell in hospital."

Chart The Stars gets off the mark

Chart The Stars (U S Navy Flag) broke her maiden at the second time of asking when she won a maiden over 1200 metres at Awapuni on Sunday. Trained by Josh Shaw, the mare is half-sister to Shaw's dual Group 1-placed stablestar Faraglioni (El Roca) and she got off the mark with a 0.8-length victory over Niemi (Microphone). Faraglioni injured a suspensory ligament in June of this year and has been retired to the broodmare paddock, visiting high-profile new Coolmore stallion City Of Troy (Justify) this spring. "It was sad to see Faraglioni go, but she really did us proud through her career," Shaw said. "It's nice to have a talented half-sister to carry on with, and hopefully she has a bit more ahead of her. That was a good, tough win today. She really stuck her neck out when she needed to and held on well. She's always shown us a huge amount of ability, right from the start, but she's just been a bit of a time job. Her legs can go pretty fast, but sometimes her brain goes even faster. It's just been a matter of giving her the time and education that she needs. Today's win shows that she's starting to get there now. She might head out in the paddock now and then come back even better with this bit more experience under her belt."

Cognito loving life on the South Island

Cognito (So You Think) wound back the clock on Saturday when he backed up his first-up victory at Riccarton with another win at the track, this time in an open event over 1800 metres. Trained by Mark Walker and Sam Bergerson, the Te Akau-raced gelding defeated Proserve (Proisir) by 0.8 lengths with another length back to Riviera Rebel (Pure Champion) in third. "It's really good to



see him back in this sort of form," co-trainer Mark Walker said. "He showed so much in his three-year-old season. "It has been frustrating with him since then, but after he had the kissing spine surgery to fix his back pain, he's come back like a new horse. His first-up win suggested he was free of the injury, and it was another really good win on Saturday. He's enjoying being down in our South Island stable at Riccarton. Hunter [Durrant] and the team have got him going really well, and he'll get up to 2000 metres next start for the North Canterbury Cup [on September 27]."

Pivotal Ten named South Island Horse of the Year

The Christchurch Casino South Island Racing Awards were presented during a function at Riccarton Park Racecourse on Friday, with standout three-year-old filly Pivotal Ten (Ten Sovereigns) named Horse of the Year and Champion Three-Year-Old. The Samantha Wynne-trained filly had seven starts last season for five wins including three at stakes level. She won the NZB Insurance Stakes (Listed, 1400m) at Wingatui on Boxing Day, then romped home by six lengths in the Gore Guineas (Listed, 1355m) and by eight and three-quarter lengths in the Southland Guineas (Listed, 1400m). She earned \$296,550 in stakes. Pivotal Ten is raced by Colin Wightman, who bought her for \$15,000 from the 2022 National Weanling Sale. He was later joined in the ownership by Cambridge Stud's Sir Brendan and Lady Jo Lindsay. Pivotal Ten is now being trained in Australia by Ben, Will and JD Hayes. JPN: Kamunyak makes successful return at Hanshin

Last seen winning the Yushun Himba (Gr 1, 2400m) in May, the Yasuo Tomomichi-trained Kamunyak (3 f Black Tide - Dance Amiga by Sakura Bakushin O) made a winning comeback with a victory in the Sho Rose Stakes (Gr 2, 1800m) at Hanshin on Sunday. The three-year-old filly beat Theresa (Admire Mars) by a length and a half with Sena Style (Sottsass) finishing a further neck away in third.

First for Sergei Prokofiev

Sergei Prokofiev (Scat Daddy), a resident at Whitsbury Manor Stud, sired his first elite-level winner when the Amo Racing-owned Arizona Blaze (3 c ex Liberisque by Equiano) proved too strong for his rivals in the Flying Five Stakes (Gr 1, 5f) at the Curragh on Sunday.

Henry Dwyer's Asfoora (Flying Artie) couldn't repeat her Nunthorpe Stakes (Gr 1, 5f) heroics, fading in the final stages to finish seventh.

Ridden by David Egan and trained by Adrian Murray, Arizona Blaze motored away to beat Nighteyes (Night Of Thunder) by a cosy length. Bucanero Fuerte (Wootton Bassett), who, like the winner, also sports the purple colours of Kia Joorabchian, finished a brave third.

A winner of the Marble Hill Stakes (Gr 3, 6f) as a juvenile, the three-year-old colt won a Group 3 in France in May, before finishing second behind Time For Sandals (Sands Of Mali) in the Commonwealth Cup (Gr 1, 6f) at Royal Ascot and bounced back to form in the Sapphire Stakes (Gr 2, 5f) in July.

He came into Sunday's Group 1 off the

back of a lacklustre 11th-placed finish in the Nunthorpe and Egan was happy to be on board the winner, having had to choose between him and Bucanero Fuerte.

Egan said: "I was chewing the ear off a lot of people, getting their opinions, but at the end of the day I had to go with my gut feeling and I was glad to be on Arizona.

"I always knew Bucanero would run a solid race and he took me into it a long way. For that horse to come back from what he's been through, it's a credit to the team."

The delighted rider added: "If anyone deserves a Group 1, it's Arizona. He was narrowly defeated as a juvenile and nearly won the Commonwealth Cup. I'm delighted for him today as the son of Sergei Prokofiev — he's a Group 1 horse and they've been campaigning him for that.

"Another Group 1 for Kia and for myself is very gracious and humbling — onto the next one!"

Bought by Amanda Skiffington for 36,000gns at the Tattersalls December Foal Sale in 2022, the colt then sold to Rodrigo Goncalves and Aguiar Bloodstock for £82,000 at the Goffs UK Premier Yearling Sale the following year.



International

Nine for Starspangledbanner

Former shuttler Starspangledbanner (Choisir) sired his ninth stakes winner courtesy of Precise's (2 f ex Way To My Heart by Galileo) win in the Moyglare Stud Stakes (Gr 1, 7f) at the Curragh on Sunday. The filly came into the race off the back of a victory in the Prestige Fillies' Stakes (Gr 3, 7f) at Goodwood and she built on that performance to beat her stablemate Beautify (Wootton Bassett) by three-quarters of a length. Venetian Sun (Starman), a last start winner of the Prix Morny (Gr 1, 1200m), was a further length and three-quarters away in third. Precise is out of the placed Galileo (Sadler's Wells) mare Way To My Heart, herself a sister to Listed winner and Group 1-placed Kingsfisher. Starspangledbanner shuttled to Coolmore Australia for the final time in 2024, covering 74 mares at a fee of \$44,000 (inc GST).

90 for Siyouni

Haras de Bonneval-based sire Siyouni (Pivotal) chalked up his 90th individual stakes winner when the Francis Graffard-trained Roshvar (4 g ex Roshanara by Sea The Stars) landed the Prix Du Pin (Gr 3, 1400m) at Longchamp on Sunday. Last seen winning a conditions race at Dieppe, the gelding had no issues with the step up in class, beating Poet Master (5 g ex Madeline by Kodiak) by half a length. Siam Paragon (Shalaa) was another three and a half lengths away in third. Bred and raced by Haras De S A Aga Khan Scea, the gelding is out of the Listed-placed mare Roshanara (Sea The Stars), making him a half-brother to stakes winner Rozgar (Exceed And Excel). Roshanara herself a daughter of Rosawa (Sinndar) and she is also the dam of Group 1 winner Rosanara (Sinndar).

First for Without Parole

Newsells Park resident Without Parole (Frankel) sired his first Group 1 winner when his son Zavatari (2 c ex Zerouna by Siyouni) kept his perfect record intact in the Vincent O'Brien National Stakes (Gr 1, 7f) at the Curragh on Sunday. Trained by Eve Johnson Houghton, the two-year-old colt continued on his steep upward trajectory when he defeated Aidan

CAN: Notable Speech shines in Woodbine Mile

Last year's English 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1m) winner Notable Speech (4 c ex Dubawi - Swift Rose by Invincible Spirit) gained a first success this season when delivering a flashing late run to land the Woodbine Mile Stakes (Gr 1, 8f) at Woodbine on Saturday.

The four-year-old had not won since the Sussex Stakes (Gr 1, 1m) last July and was most recently denied by a head in the Jacques le Marois (Gr 1, 1600m), but he made the trip to Toronto well worth the effort when storming home under William Buick to land the Grade 1 contest.

Notable Speech had four rivals ahead of him entering the home straight but switched gears impressively to get his head in front of My Boy Prince (Cairo Prince) before extending his lead in the final furlong to strike by a length and three-quarters.

"The normal outer turf track here is beautiful, a European style of racing," Buick told Bloodhorse.com. "Now, obviously, we're on the inside track for these races, so it changes the dynamics a lot and our horses find it challenging.

"I was not going to give up my

position on Notable Speech. He's an experienced horse so I could do that with him. You have to be brave for a little bit there, but he was. Once he got into that position, he relaxed beautifully and he got into a nice rhythm. For me, he was winning from there on out."

It was a third top-level success for the son of Dubawi (Dubai Millennium), who landed the 2,000 Guineas last term before victory at Glorious Goodwood. He not only secured his third major prize but also became the third winner of the Woodbine Mile for Appleby in the last four years, with the trainer previously striking with two other sons of Dubawi in Master Of The Seas and Modern Games.

Those two both went on to follow up in the Breeders' Cup Mile (Gr 1, 8f), and Notable Speech is expected to chart a similar route having earned his 'win and you're in' ticket to Del Mar in November for a race in which he was third last year.

Buick added: "It was very frustrating in the Jacques le Marois. He should have won that day, and he deserved to win. It was a hard pill to swallow, but he's put it right today. Fingers crossed, we go to Del Mar for the Mile with every chance."



O'Brien's Coventry Stakes (Gr 2, 6f) winner Gstaad (Starspangledbanner) by a head, with the official result announced after a lengthy stewards enquiry. The runner-ups stablemate Italy (Wotton Bassett) finished a further two and a half lengths away in third. Bred by John D Gunther and Ttr Bloodstock, Zavateri was sold by Newsells Park for 35,000gns to Anthony Bromley of Highflyer Bloodstock and his trainer at Book 2 of the Tattersalls October Yearling Sale last year. The colt is out of the unraced mare Zeroua (Siyouni), herself a half-sister to dual Australian Group 3 winner Zeyrek (Sea The Stars).

UK: First Group win for Harry Angel's Fair Angellica

The Richard Hughes-trained Fair Angellica (4 f Harry Angel - Fair's Fair by Lawman) scored her first Group race win when she won Sunday's Sceptre Fillies' Stakes (Gr 3, 7f) at Doncaster. Having broken through at stakes level for the first time in the Cathedral Stakes (Listed, 6f) at Salisbury, the filly added a second stakes win to her record when she bravely defeated Bright Thunder (Night Of Thunder) by short-

head. Spiritual (Invincible Spirit) finished a length and a half adrift in third. Harry Angel is standing at Darley's Kelvinside base for a fee of \$66,000 (inc GST).

Ten for Nyquist

Darley America stallion Nyquist (Uncle Mo) chalked up his tenth Grade 1 individual winner when the Riley Mott-trained Argos (2 c ex Athenian by Acclamation) took out the Summer Stakes (Gr 1, 8f) at Woodbine on Saturday. Ridden by Flavien Prat, the colt narrowly defeated British raider Wild Desert (Too Darn Hot) by a head with Two Out Hero (War Front) finishing a further length away in third. Bred by Green Lantern Stables, Argos was purchased by Rafael Stable for US\$10,000 at the Fasig-Tipton July Select Sale, before selling to his current owner David S. Romanik for US\$165,000 at the Ocala March 2YO Sale. The colt is out of German Listed winner Athenian (Acclamation), whose three other winners are headed by stakes-placed Skole (Oasis Dream).

12 for Practical Joke

In winning Saturday's Natalma Stakes (Gr 1, 8f) at Woodbine, Corsia Veloce (2 f ex Beth's Bling by City Zip) provided Coolmore America stallion Practical Joke (Into Mischief) with his 12th individual top-flight winner. Trained by Josie Carroll, the juvenile filly stayed on powerfully to beat Hot Mash (Not This Time) by half a length with another neck back to La Culasse (Knicks Go) in third. Bred by Hill 'N' Dale Farms and Mario Serrani, the filly is now raced by the latter and Glenn Sikura after going

unsold at two of her visits to the sales. Corsia Veloce is out of Listed-placed winner Beth's Bling (City Zip), who was purchased by Sikura for US\$120,000 at the Keeneland November Breeding Sale in 2016.

45 for Gun Runner

Having finished second at Listed level, the Steven Asmussen-trained Spice Runner (2 c ex Simple Surprise by Cowboy Cal) took the leap into Graded company in his stride when he took out the Iroquois Stakes (Gr 2, 8f) at Churchill Downs on Saturday. The juvenile defeated Comport (Collected) by a head with Vist (Instagrind) finishing a further five lengths adrift in third. Bred and raced by Winchell Thoroughbreds, Spice Runner is out of the stakes winner Simple Surprise making him a brother dual to Grade 1 winner Gunite.

First for Rock Your World

The Spendthrift Farm-based sire Rock Your World (Candy Ride) scored his first stakes winner on Saturday when Taken By The Wind (2 f ex Up For Grabs by First Samurai) landed the Pocahontas Stakes (Gr 3, 8f) at Churchill Downs. Trained by Kenny McPeack, the filly soared five and a quarter lengths clear of the runner-up Miss Complicated (Complexity) with a further two and a half lengths back to Jake Maker (Practical Joke) in third. Out of the winning mare Up For Grabs (First Sumurai), Taken By The Wind is a half-sister to four winners headed by Running Memories (Bahamian Squall), who was also placed at Listed level.

Britney Wong hits 20 wins with Sha Tin double

Britney Wong underlined her potential as she reached a career milestone at Sha Tin on Sunday (14 September) when the 26-year-old achieved her 20th win in Hong Kong.

She rode two winners – reducing her apprentice's claim to seven pounds from next week – on an intriguing day of racing that also featured a treble for Alexis Badel and doubles for Andrea Atzeni, Mark Newnham and Danny Shum.

"It felt really nice. I actually aimed for those last two winners (to reach 20 wins) on the last day of last season, but I couldn't achieve it," Wong said. "So I brushed myself off and tried my best today."

Wong first struck on Fight Time (Nicconi) in the first section of the Class 5 Hong Tung Handicap (1400m). Wong's ten-pound weight allowance was doubtless a factor as she held off Lyle Hewitson's fast-closing Cashiscash (Capitalist) with the line coming not a moment too soon for Fight Time.

Hall was glowing in his assessment of Wong's performance.

"She did a great job. She was caught wide, but obviously, from barrier 13, it was always going to be a chance that that could happen," Hall said. "But she kept the horse's balance, kept his rhythm and let him build his momentum up."

Wong's second winner was equally as impressive. Drawn ten in the Class 3 Oi Tung Handicap (1200m, dirt), she got a good start and immediately set about positioning Packing Bole (Deep Field) on the rail at the head of the field. From there, it was a textbook front-running performance as they comfortably held a fast-finishing Mr Energia (Swiss Ace) to wrap up a routine one-and-a-half length victory.

The second-year apprentice said the approach was all part of a plan.

"Today it was really good that the pace just

panned out as we wanted because he's a very straightforward horse," Wong said. "He always just leads and keeps on a very strong pace, and no one was trying to give me any pressure."

Badel's superb summer continued as he landed a treble that took his tally for the season to four.

Fresh from a successful stint in Japan during the off-season, which yielded 12 wins, six seconds and six thirds from 69 rides, the Frenchman has hit the ground running this term.

He opened his Sha Tin account in the second section of the Class 5 Hong Tung Handicap (1400m), aboard My Flying Angel (Zoustar), providing Frankie Lor with his first winner of the season.

The five-year-old showed a blistering turn of foot at the end of a well-paced trip from Badel, reeling in the favourite Circuit Fiery (Tavistock), who had opened up a three-length gap off the final bend.

He followed that up with a surprise victory aboard 65/1 shot Same To You (Mikki Isle) in the Class 4 Tung Wah Group Of Hospitals Challenge Cup Handicap (1200m).

Securing a race-to-race double for trainer Newnham, Badel blazed a furrow down the

middle of the straight in the last 200 metres as he swooped from last to first to claim victory.

"It was a little bit of a surprise but a nice surprise," Newnham said. "Generally, I would have thought that in Class 4 he'd need a really good barrier and a good ride. I said to Alexis: 'Don't use him early, ride him to be strong late.'"

"I said before the race: 'It's a difficult task – in Class 4, with gate 14. If Alexis wants to give us a nice surprise, we'll take it.' And it worked out that way!"

Badel completed his hat-trick in the Class 3 Wah Fu Handicap (1400m) with an on-pace ride aboard Master Of All (Charm Spirit)

The Frenchman acknowledged it had been a good start to the new campaign and attributed some of his success to the freshening effect of his spell in Japan.

"Obviously, it was a confidence booster because I was doing well without too much expectation," Badel said. "It was like some fresh air, and I feel good, I feel confident."

"I'm grateful because I've had some good support and horses in good form," Badel added. "It's a team effort. You have to deliver, but you have to be on the right ones."

Max Que (Akeed Mofeed) supplied a first win of the season for both Atzeni and Newnham

when he landed a first career win in the first section of the Class 4 Kwong Fuk Handicap (1400m). The five-year-old finally broke his duck when he overtook Aeroinvincible (Per Incanto) at the 100-metre mark to prevail by one-and-a-half lengths.

Jamie Richards' fine start to the season continued as he claimed the first section of the Class 4 Lok Wah Handicap (1200m) with Jubilant Winner (Capitalist), ridden by Atzeni, providing his fifth win of the campaign. Having finished the 2024/25 season with 22 winners, Richards has made a rapid start to the current season.

A contender for the most impressive performance of the day was the blistering run from Lyle Hewitson-ridden Metro Power (Overshare), who claimed the Class 3 Mei Tung Handicap (1000m) for David Hayes. The four-year-old flew home along the Sha Tin straight course in a remarkable 55.33s.

Zac Purton took the Class 4 Hing Wah Handicap (1200m, dirt) aboard Blazing Wind (Deep Field). The favourite had opened up a

lengthy gap in the first dirt contest of the season and looked to be cruising to a second career victory for Danny Shum. But under top weight, he was eventually looking for the line as Daily Trophy (Tarzino) rocketed down the straight to get within a head of Blazing Wind.

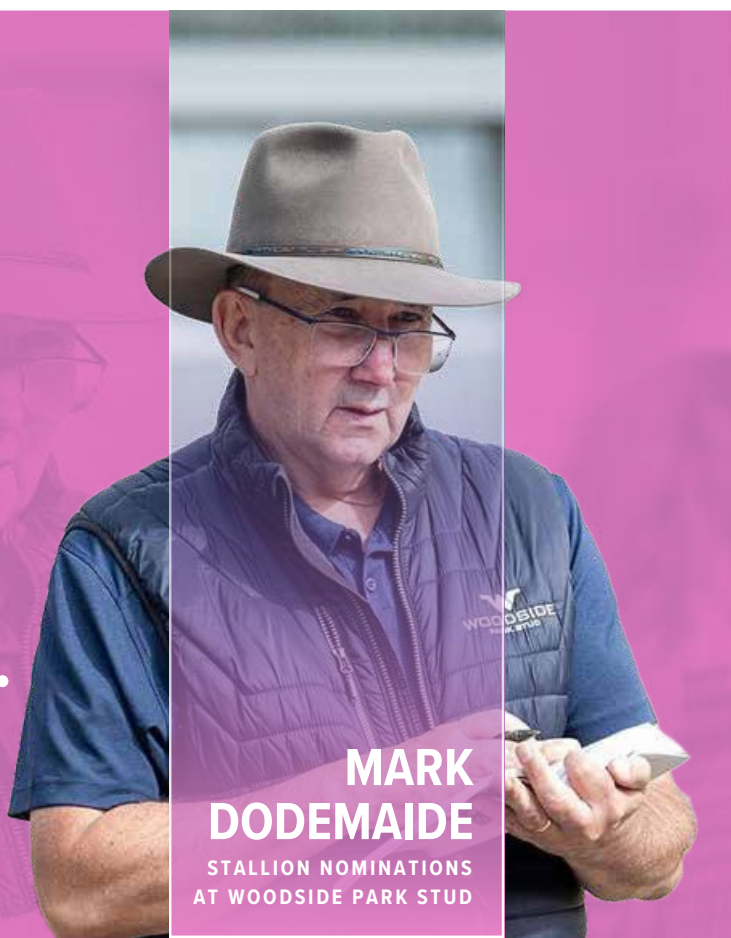

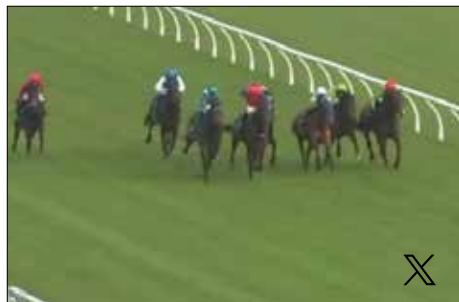
