Sir Delius digs deep to land classy Underwood Stakes win

Imported star Sir Delius (Frankel) announced himself as a spring staying force after producing a fighting victory in Saturday's Underwood Stakes (Gr 1, 1800m) at Caulfield, a performance that confirmed the entire as a major player in both the Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) and the Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m).

Seemingly beaten when Buckaroo (Fastnet Rock) surged past him early in the straight, Sir Delius rallied under Craig Williams to claw

back the margin and score by a half-length, with outsider Golden Path (Belardo) just 0.02 lengths away in third.

Sent out the \$2.10 favourite, the win was his first Group 1 triumph and the latest step on a journey that began in France and has been carefully mapped out by co-trainers Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott.

"It's the most exciting thing I've seen in years," Waterhouse said after claiming her third Underwood in four years, following Alligator Blood's (All Too Hard) back-to-back successes in 2022 and 2023.

Sepals superb to land maiden Group 1 in Sir Rupert Clarke

An in-form Craig Williams added a remarkable eighth Sir Rupert Clarke Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) to his record on Saturday as he guided the Cliff Brown-trained Sepals (Calyx) to a gritty breakthrough top-flight victory in the \$1 million handicap.

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“He was not in a good position throughout the race. He was trying, trying [to get a position] and when he came around the home straight, he wasn’t any good thing, but then all of a sudden he saw the winning post, and he took off. He was just fabulous.”

Raced as Delius in Europe, the four-year-old son of Frankel (Galileo) was trained by Jean-Claude Rouget for Coolmore and proved his quality with three wins, including the Prix du Lys (Gr 3, 2400m). He also finished third in the Grand Prix de Paris (Gr 1, 2400m) and second in the Prix Niel (Gr 2, 2400m) before tackling the Prix de l’Arc de Triomphe (Gr 1, 2400m) last October, in which he wasn’t disgraced when finishing eighth behind Bluestocking (Camelot).

When offered at the 2024 Tattersalls Autumn Horses in Training Sale, he topped the auction at a record 1,300,000gns. Waterhouse and Bott, alongside Sir Owen Glenn’s Go Bloodstock, Hubie De Burgh and Johnny McKeever, signed the ticket, eclipsing the previous sale record of 1,000,000gns.

“He was always purchased as a Melbourne Cup prospect,” Bott explained at the time of Sir Delius’ Australian debut win in the JRA Chairman’s Handicap (Gr 3, 2000m) at Doomben in May.

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Saturday’s victory showcased the winner’s temperament as well as talent, as he was forced to dig deep on an unfamiliar way of going.

“He’s just such a weapon and when Blake [Shinn] came past me [on Buckaroo] I thought ‘oh no’, but I just kept urging him,” Williams said post-race. “I have always said he reminds me of [Melbourne Cup winner] Dunaden. He’s got that great tenacity and great will to win. He laid back his ears and we got the win today.”

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Continued from page 2 “The discussion we had pre-race [was] to let him be a really good horse. He gave me a really good run from an awkward draw [barrier 11]. When the chips were down, he had to be tough.”

Waterhouse, who trained Fiorente (Monsun) to Melbourne Cup glory in 2013, has plotted a near-identical path for Sir Delius. Next stop is the Might And Power (Gr 1, 2000m) at Caulfield on October 11, followed by the Cox Plate at The Valley on October 25 before the Melbourne Cup at Flemington on November 4.

“They are both very similar, both are very handsome horses,” Waterhouse said of the comparison. “They have fabulous attitudes, like a will to win. They’re a pleasure to ride, they’re big-striding horses and just know where the winning post is.”

The trainer acknowledged that it was her co-trainer who insisted the Underwood was the right race after a narrow second in the Chelmsford Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m) last time out.

“It was Adrian’s decision to send him to Melbourne,” she said. “And it was the right one.”

Bred by David and Trish Brown of Furnace Mill Stud, Sir Delius is out of Whatami (Daylami), making him a brother to Wolferton Stakes (Listed, 1m 2f) victor Juan Elcano.

Sir Delius became the 40th individual Group 1 winner for Frankel, and the latest addition to his sire’s growing southern hemisphere legacy, which includes Group 1 winners Hungry Heart, Converge and Mirage Dancer.

Waterhouse and Bott are now firmly focused on keeping Sir Delius sound and peaking for November’s first Tuesday. Striking

his fifth career win from just nine starts, the performance also tightened the colt’s grip on Melbourne Cup betting, where he now shares favouritism with Al Riffa (Wootton Bassett).

“We’ve got a great horse, it’s [the Melbourne Cup] a great race, it’s got the world talking,” Waterhouse said.

“He was trying all the way. He’s a horse that knows where the post is — and that’s what you need.”

Sepsals superb to land maiden Group 1 in Sir Rupert Clarke

An in-form Craig Williams added a remarkable eighth Sir Rupert Clarke Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) to his record on Saturday as he guided the Cliff Brown-trained Sepsals (Calyx) to a gritty breakthrough top-flight victory in the \$1 million handicap.

Able to make the 52-kilogram lightweight, Williams was replacing Sepsals’ last-start partner Ethan Brown and produced a masterful ride,

urging the progressive four-year-old gelding to sit second after a tardy start from barrier 14 of 15.

The pair kicked clear upon straightening and Sepsals – lining up for just his seventh start off the back of a brilliant first-up win over course and distance last month – was strong to line, holding off the challenge of Miss Roubini (Zoustar) to score by 0.8 lengths, with the autumn’s Australian Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Feroce (Super Seth) finishing just 0.3 lengths further away in third.

Angel Capital (Harry Angel), sent off the \$2.90 favourite ahead of Sepsals (\$3.50), suffered a troubled passage from barrier 12 and flashed home late to take fourth. The winning time of 1m 21.39s was just 0.19s outside of the course record on the Good 3 surface.

For Cliff Brown, a multiple Group 1-winning trainer before he departed for Singapore in 2007, the win was a first elite-level triumph since his return from that now-obsolete jurisdiction four years ago.

Continued from page 3 "To win this race, it's tremendous," Brown said. "These are races I grew up with as a kid and that was a long time ago. To win it, it's very special."

The Mornington-based trainer admitted his surprise at seeing Williams take up a forward position early.

"It was quite interesting," he said.

"He came out and said I will just let him find his feet. That went out the window, but that's what he does, and that's why you put the best on. He's done a great job."

Sepals has a nomination for this year's Epsom Handicap (Gr 1, 1600m) but Brown said there are no plans in store as to where the gelding would head next.

"I'll see what the boys want to do, but this is very special," the winning trainer said.

"I'm really pleased for everyone. [Wife] Jo and the kids and the staff, they're amazing. There's a lot of work that goes into these horses. He's a special horse and he deserves the attention that he gets."

Strengthening his lead as the most

successful jockey in the race's history, Williams was completing a Group 1 double having also landed the Underwood Stakes (Gr 1, 1800m) aboard the impressive Sir Delius (Frankel) 40 minutes earlier.

It was therefore the veteran rider's third Group 1 in the space of a week, adding to victory onboard Mr Brightside (Bullbars) in last Saturday's Makybe Diva Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m).

Williams was impressed with Sepals' performance, adding there are bigger things in store for the son of late Coolmore sire Calyx (Kingman).

"It's hard to win Group 1s and he's done it and that's not it for this horse. He's got more to come," he said.

"He's got such a good action, he's got a great motor, and I was very fortunate to ride him today."

Bred by Greg Perry and an \$80,000 purchase for his trainer at the 2023 Inglis Classic Yearling Sale, Sepals is the first foal and first winner out of Casino Prince (Flying Spur) mare What's New, who was prepared by Brown to become

Singapore's Champion Four-Year-Old and Older Female in 2019.

His fourth dam is Good Faith (Straight Strike), the dam of two stakes winners and herself a winner of the Sistema Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) who was named the top filly on the 1996-97 Australasian Two-Year-Old Classification.

In winning the Sir Rupert Clarke, Sepals (4 g Calyx – What's New by Casino Prince) became the first Group 1 winner for Coolmore's ill-fated Calyx, who died aged nine due to an acute foot injury in May.

Rapid stakes double for Extreme Choice

A more expansive track at Caulfield and the step up to 1400 metres for the first time in Saturday's Caulfield Guineas Prelude (Gr 3, 1400m) brought out the best in Estremo (Extreme Choice) as the colt laid down a marker for the stallion-making feature in three weeks' time.

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Continued from page 4 Some 20 minutes later at Randwick, Apocalyptic made it a quickfire stakes double for her remarkable sire Extreme Choice (Not A Single Doubt) when she made it back-to-back wins with a dominant display in the Tea Rose Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m).

Trainer Michael Freedman now has a decision to make on whether to back up his in-form filly in next Saturday's Golden Rose Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m), for which she is now the \$7 fourth favourite behind Tempted (Street Boss).

There is no doubt where Estremo's immediate future lies, however, with Chris Waller's right-hand man Charlie Duckworth confirming that the colt would take his place in the Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) after becoming his trainer's first winner of the Prelude.

Waller may have endured a barren run in the Prelude but he unquestionably knows what it takes to win the big one, having masterminded a hat-trick of Caulfield Guineas victories over the past decade - most notably when The Autumn Sun (Redoute's Choice) blitzed his rivals back in 2018.

The Autumn Sun, who has returned to stud duties at Arrowfield for the upcoming breeding season, started at the prohibitive price of \$1.70 that day whereas Estremo, following two solid rather than spectacular outings at Moonee Valley, jumped at the more enticing odds of \$7 in Saturday's seven-runner Prelude.

The old adage about horses for courses may ring true in the case of Estremo, who looked much more comfortable at Caulfield

than he did navigating The Valley's tight turns in the McKenzie Stakes (Listed, 1200m), won on debut by Clinton McDonald's speedster Rosberg (Deep Field).

Waller conceded he may have erred in not stepping Estremo up in trip sooner in his preparation but, as ever, the master trainer got his preparations spot-on this time with the colt's fact-finding mission at Caulfield on Tuesday morning producing the desired outcome.

With the Good 4 surface (upgraded to a Good 3 after race two) favouring on-speed runners, the Matt Laurie-trained colt Vega For Luck (Lucky Vega) looked to have stolen a march on his rivals but under the urgings of Ben Melham, Estremo eventually reeled in the long-time leader to prevail by 0.1 lengths with race favourite Planet Red (Admire Mars) running into third - beaten 1.3 lengths.

Given the manner of his powerful finish, albeit off a muddling tempo, the step up to the mile in the Caulfield Guineas should only enhance Estremo's prospects of becoming the first horse since Helmet (Exceed And Excel) in 2011 to achieve the Prelude-Guineas double.

"He came here early in the week to have a look around and Ben [Melham] was really happy with that piece of work, so I think that had him in good stead for today," said Duckworth.

"The extra distance was brilliant and I think that with Ben having had that sit on him earlier in the week, it just allowed him the confidence to ride him where he wanted to ride him. He obviously had to dig deep late and he had to

fight all the way to the line but it was a great win.

"I think it was just a case of The Valley getting him beaten on the two previous occasions. We sort of ummed and ahed over whether we ran that second time around The Valley [in the McKenzie Stakes], because he was probably already looking for the 1400 metres.

"But we opted to run as he was well-fancied in the market and there were enough indications that he'd taken benefit from his first go around there. It didn't pan out for us that day, but it has today."

Stablemate Autumn Boy (The Autumn Sun), who contests next week's Golden Rose in Sydney before making the journey south to Melbourne, is currently the \$4 favourite for the Caulfield Guineas after he resumed with an eye-catching second in the Ming Dynasty (Gr 3, 1400m).

Estremo had his odds trimmed to \$18 from an opening quote of \$51 but despite the disparity in the market between the two stable companions, Duckworth believes that his familiarity with Caulfield could give the Prelude winner a key advantage.

"Obviously we've got a quartet of horses heading towards a Golden Rose next weekend, and some of them would be likely to then come down to the Caulfield Guineas," said Duckworth.

"But he [Estremo] will have the advantage of winning around here, whereas they won't. It's always hard to exactly measure up, because course specialists are a big thing and it could give him a significant advantage, having that experience."

Melham made it back-to-back wins in the Prelude having piloted Angel Capital (Harry Angel) - before he joined Waller's stables - to victory 12 months ago.

Melham is likely to be glued to Rosberg's back but given the crack colt is set to stick to sprint trips with an eye on the Coolmore Stud Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m), there is every chance he will be reunited in the Caulfield Guineas with Estremo.

"He's a horse that's got nice ability and, just watching him, he didn't look like he was really suited to Moonee Valley and he was probably looking for the trip," said Melham.

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"I worked him the other morning and I thought he's a horse that you just want to keep happy. If you can keep him happy and balanced, he'll run well for you. He had a beautiful run, he tracked up behind the leader then came off his back, and it was pretty soft in the end.

"I didn't really get to the bottom of him, he did just enough to win. He's had a good experience and he was good at the trip."

Estremo became Extreme Choice's second individual stakes winner of the season after Apocalyptic got her fertility-challenged father on the board courtesy of her win in the Furious Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m).

Estremo was a \$230,000 purchase by Denise Martin's Star Thoroughbreds syndicate from the Newgate Farm draft at last year's Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale. Martin has enjoyed top level success with Extreme Choice, having raced Group 1-winning mare Espiona in her distinctive purple colours.

He is the best of five winners to come out of the metro-winning Street Cry (Machiavellian) mare Tree Of Jesse, herself a half-sister to stakes winner Related (Elusive Quality). Extreme Choice is standing at a career-high fee of \$330,000 (inc GST) this season.

Despite not having a runner in the Prelude, Tony and Calvin McEvoy will have been interested observers in the result, having purchased Estremo's sister for \$200,000 at this year's Inglis Melbourne Premier Yearling Sale.

Apocalyptic all class to claim Tea Rose Stakes

Apocalyptic (Extreme Choice) confirmed herself a serious filly at Randwick on Saturday when she ran away with the Tea Rose Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m).

It was the second victory of the Princess Series for the daughter of Newgate Farm's Extreme Choice (Not A Single Doubt) having landed the Furious Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) in thrilling style on September 6 – just her second start after a runner-up finish on debut last December, with a foot abscess ruling her out of the autumn.

Despite travelling in a less-than-ideal

position from barrier eight on Saturday – with her and jockey Tommy Berry forced to sit three-wide for the majority of the 1400-metre contest – the Michael Freedman-trained filly showed professionalism beyond her experience to relax and kick on when asked.

Letting down at the 200 metres, the striking three-year-old swiftly hit the front and stretched clear, making it two Group 2 victories from as many starts this preparation by 1.7 lengths, with a jubilant Berry lifting out of his irons to salute on the line.

Sent off a \$3 chance after her last-start heroics, the winner defeated Artistic Venture (Trapeze Artist), who out-ran her \$41 odds, with \$2.50 favourite and Furious Stakes second Tupakara (Trapeze Artist) crossing the line another 0.4 lengths behind in third.

Freedman admitted to concern over the gate pre-race and was delighted to see his filly prove a class above her ten rivals.

"I think she's pretty special," the trainer said.

"I was very impressed with her first-up two weeks ago but overcoming a few difficulties there today with the wide run, through no fault of Tommy's, we were always worried about that gate.

"To let down like she did, from a training perspective, you don't get too many horses that can do that."

Apocalyptic was cut from \$4.50 to a clear-cut \$2.20 favourite for the Flight Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) at Randwick on October 4, and her trainer believes another step up in trip for the Group 1 is likely to suit.

"I'll speak to Tommy and see what he thinks but she did relax a little bit better today even though she didn't have cover, which gives me some encouragement going up to the mile in two weeks' time should suit her," Freedman said.

"She has always given us the impression the longer trip should suit so hopefully it will play that way."

Berry was not overly concerned when he had to track wide on Apocalyptic but was

aware the race may have been a hard watch for Freedman.

"I would have loved a heart monitor on Michael halfway around," the winning rider quipped.

"We both knew before the race it was a very tricky barrier. She's got such a big stride...I didn't really mind being wide on her, it was better than being in.

"We've had a big wrap on her for a long time and I've had wraps on horses before and it doesn't come to fruition, which today it has."

Apocalyptic (3 f Extreme Choice – Shadow by Medaglia D'Oro) was a \$400,000 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale purchase by MyRacehorse, her trainer and Julian Blaxland Bloodstock from the Coolmore Stud draft in 2024.

Bred by Kate Nivison's Etak Thoroughbreds, she is the second foal and second winner out of Shadow (Medaglia D'Oro), a granddaughter of dual Group 1 winner Virage De Fortune (Anabaa) from the family of champion Emancipation (Bletchingly).

Apocalyptic's brother sold to Chris Waller Racing, Mulcaster Bloodstock and B2B Thoroughbreds for \$1.7 million at Inglis Easter Yearling Sale earlier this year. Shadow was covered late last season by Pierro (Lonhro) after missing to Extreme Choice.

First for Calyx

Bred by Greg Perry and an \$80,000 purchase for his trainer at the 2023 Inglis Classic Yearling Sale, Sepals is the first foal and first winner out of Casino Prince (Flying Spur) mare What's New, who was prepared by Brown to become Singapore's Champion Four-Year-Old and Older Female in 2019. His fourth dam is Good Faith (Straight Strike), the dam of two stakes winners and herself a winner of the Sistema Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) who was named the top filly on the 1996-97 Australasian Two-Year-Old Classification. Calyx, who shuttled to Coolmore Australia in 2020 and 2021, died in May of an acute foot injury.

40 for Frankel

Juddmonte's all-conquering sire Frankel (Galileo) was provided with his 40th individual elite-level winner on Saturday when the Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott-trained Sir Delius (5 h ex Whatami by Daylami) scored in the Underwood Stakes (Gr 1, 1800m) at Caulfield. Originally purchased by MV Magnier from the 2021 Tattersalls December Foal Sale for 675,000gns, Sir Delius was then re-sold to De Burgh Equine, McKeever Bloodstock and Go Bloodstock for 1,300,000gns at last October's

Tattersalls Autumn Horses-In-Training Sale and races in the colours of Sir Owen Glen's Go Bloodstock. He is the best of five winners out of the Daylami (Doyoun) mare Whatami, whose immediate family includes Champion US mare Uni (More Than Ready), making Sir Delius a brother to the Listed-winning and multiple Group 2-placed Juan Elcano and a half-brother to Group 3 winner Nkosikazi (Cape Cross). Frankel stood the 2025 northern hemisphere breeding season at Banstead Manor Stud for a fee of £350,000 (approx. AU\$715,130).

16 for Extreme Choice

Newgate Farm's flagship stallion Extreme Choice (Not A Single Doubt) added a 16th individual stakes winner to his tally when Estremo (3 c ex Tree Of Jesse by Street Cry) narrowly scored in the Caulfield Guineas Prelude (Gr 3, 1400m). Bred by SF Bloodstock and Blake Sandblom, Estremo was a \$230,000 purchase by Denise Martin's Star Thoroughbreds syndicate from the Newgate Farm draft at last year's Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale. He is the best of five winners out of metro-winning Street Cry (Machiavellian) mare Tree Of Jesse, herself a half-sister to stakes winner Related (Elusive Quality). Extreme Choice is standing at a career-high fee of \$330,000 (inc GST).

Half Yours impresses in Naturalism Stakes

The Tony and Calvin McEvoy-trained Half Yours (5 g St Jean - La Gazelle by Desert

King) took another step up the staying ladder at Caulfield on Saturday when dominating proceedings in the Naturalism Stakes (Gr 3, 2000m). Winner of the Caloundra Cup (Listed, 2400m) two starts previous, the lightly raced five-year-old gelding laid down a Caulfield Cup (Gr 1, 2400m) marker this weekend as he registered a three and a half lengths victory over Berkshire Breeze (Mastercraftsman), with Grand Pierro (Pierro) a further 0.2 lengths back in third. The McEvoy's had planned to run Half Yours in Sydney on Saturday before then aiming him at The Metropolitan (Gr 1, 2400m) at Randwick on October 4, but with the gelding only an emergency for his intended target, connections decided to switch to the Naturalism Stakes. "That was the big question through the week," Calvin McEvoy said. "Dad and I, we tossed up what to do. He was in Sydney, as we always had planned to run him in Kingston Town and at the last minute decided to accept here. We always knew that if he came down here to Melbourne and won, he'd probably stay here. Look, he's in the Caulfield Cup now, he's proven on a good track, so I think we'll be all systems go to the Caulfield Cup. He was bred by Janice and the late Col McKenna and was very well-handled early by the Maher team. We loved the profile, he had a good rating, and we really wanted to get him. We didn't think we'd have to spend the money we did [\$305,000] but thank God we did. Ever since we've had him, he's been straightforward, been a lovely horse to train, and we haven't got to his ceiling yet."



Gilded Water on the Cup charge

King Charles III and Queen Camilla will have woken up to a royal winner at Caulfield on Saturday after their five-year-old gelding Gilded Water (Fastnet Rock) landed a Benchmark 84 (2000m) contest. Closing out what was a thrilling day of action on the Caulfield card, the Ciaron Maher-trained son of Fastnet Rock (Danehill) hit the front approaching the final 200 metres and was eased down dramatically inside the final 50 metres to land a two-length success over Unlimited (Saxon Warrior). There was a further 0.2 lengths back to Kings Valley (Territories) in third. Out of the winning Galileo (Sadler's Wells) mare Fiery Sunset, Gilded Water is a half-brother to 2024 Sydney Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) hero Circle Of Fire (Almanzor) and also to Group 3 scorer Evening Sun (Muhaarar).

Nine for Vadamos

With Your Blessing (7 g ex Super Trouper by Darci Brahma) became the ninth individual stakes winner for Vadamos (Monsun) when taking out Saturday's Bill Ritchie Handicap (Gr 3, 1400m) at Randwick. Ridden by Alysha Collett for trainer John Thompson, the seven-year-old gelding proved 0.4 lengths too strong for Bosustow (Blue Point) with a further 1.3 lengths back to the third-placed Depth Of Character (Deep Field). With Your Blessing is the best of five foals to race out of Super Trouper (Darci Brahma), who is also the dam of the six-time winner Super Alana (Belardo). Super Trouper has a three-year-old Ole Kirk (Written Tycoon) filly who has been named Che Ole, and she produced a filly foal by State Of Rest (Starspangledbanner) last spring. Vadamos has not returned to Rich Hill Stud for the 2025 breeding season, and stands at Grange Stud in the northern hemisphere.

Six for Ghaiyyath

Darley's former shuttler Ghaiyyath (Dubawi) sired his first stakes winner in Australia and sixth individual stakes winner overall on Saturday when Yum (3 f ex Dream Food by Snitzel) took out the Jim Moloney Stakes (Listed, 1400m) at Caulfield.

Coming into the race on the back off a maiden success at Seymour on August 15, the three-year-old was sent off a \$21 chance in the 11-runner Listed contest but defied those odds in dramatic late style.

Ridden by Jamie Mott, the John McArdle-trained filly sat down the field inside the 300-metre mark but made up ground when pulled out wide by her jockey.

Entering the last 100 metres, Yum produced a late burst of speed to gain the lead inside the final 50 metres and beat Chateau Eze (Frankel) by 0.8 lengths with just 0.1 lengths further back to the third-placed Zany Girl (Needs Further).

"We knew she had the finish and we were quietly confident coming here," said McArdle. "She's shown us plenty at home. She trialled ten days ago and trialled probably as good as a horse could at Mornington on the course proper. So we were happy with the

filly coming here.

"I was a little bit worried when the race panned out like it did, but Jamie's got supreme confidence in her turn of foot and it was there today when we needed it."

On where his filly will head next, McArdle said a Group 1 event could be on the cards before the season is out.

"She'll head to the Edward Manifold in two weeks and then we'll make a plan from there. She is a November foal, but if she holds up, she'll head towards the [VRC] Oaks," he said.

"She's a nice filly, she's bred to stay. Ken and Jen Breese are great supporters, so it was great to get a stakes win for them and obviously Motty, he does a lot of work with them, so he knows what he's got under the hood and did the job today."

Bred by Ken and Jen Breese, Yum is one of four winners to come out of the Snitzel (Redoute's Choice) mare Dream Food, herself a half-sister to the Group 2-winning and Group 1-placed I'll Have A Bit (Smart Missile).

Having shuttled to Australia for the previous four seasons, Ghaiyyath has not returned to Darley's Northwood Park base for 2025.



Birdman claims first Australian stakes win

In what proved to be the narrowest of margins, the Chris Waller-trained Birdman (4 g Free Eagle - Carol by Acclamation) secured his second career stakes win and first win in Australia at the eighth attempt when he landed the Kingston Town Stakes (Gr 3, 2000m) at Randwick. Ridden by Kerrin McEvoy, the four-year-old gelding seemed to have matters under control entering the final 200 metres but a late rally from fellow Irish import Adelaide River (Australia) saw the pair involved in a photo-finish, in which Birdman narrowly got the verdict. The front pair finished a further 3.8 lengths clear of Etna Rosso (Decorated Knight) back in third. "It is [overdue] from a punter's perspective. From our perspective, he's just steadily been working towards something. But he needed to start doing it," said Waller. "His fresh up runs were good, he got to a more suitable distance today and had a lovely draw, a nice run in transit, and yeah, a good confident ride." Waller said he would first speak to Ozzie Kheir and the ownership group before any decision was made on Birdman's next start. "I'll have a talk to connections. They are great tacticians and planners of races, so I use their knowledge a lot," he said. "Logically, he's heading the right way towards the Cups - that's what he was brought for a year out, and it's coming together nicely for him."

Fangirl goes back-to-back in 7 Stakes

Chris Waller had both bases covered in Saturday's \$1 million 7 Stakes (1600m) at Randwick, with Fangirl (7 m Sebring - Little Surfer Girl by Encosta De Lago) edging out stablemate Lindermann (Lonhro) in a tight finish to repeat her victory in the race 12 months ago. Sent out the \$2.05 favourite, Fangirl settled midfield under James McDonald before surging late to deny \$5 hope Lindermann, who had set strong sectionals in front and went down fighting by 0.02 lengths. Ceolwulf (Tavistock) was another two lengths away in third. "I actually thought Lindermann had won but when it's the stablemate fighting out the photo finish you're not too concerned. Great result," Waller said. "Full credit to Fangirl and James.

Joliestar produces perfect Everest trial with Shorts win

Chris Waller's star mare Joliestar (5 m Zoustar - Jolie Bay by Fastnet Rock) announced herself as a genuine contender for next month's Everest (Gr 1, 1200m) with a dominant performance in Saturday's \$1 million The Shorts (Gr 2, 1100m) at Randwick.

Sent out a \$4.80 chance, the Kingsford-Smith Cup (Gr 1, 1200m) heroine was posted deep throughout but never flinched under James McDonald, surging clear to beat Briasa (Smart Missile) by 1.2 lengths with Generosity (Divine Prophet) running on for third another length behind.

"I only had one objective and that was to get her into a smooth rhythm, I didn't want a stop-start affair," McDonald said. "She slid around, albeit deep, but how I was thinking was Briasa was the one to beat and he was just inside me. She's a solid horse that runs

seven furlongs, that was thrilling and she deserves a spot in The Everest. I think she will make her presence felt."

Waller was glowing in his assessment of the mare's progression. "She was awesome. She's come back well, and she's four weeks out from a very big race," he said. "We haven't asked her [to do a lot] to be truthful, but I can see a more mature horse now."

The win catapulted Joliestar into \$7 second favouritism for the \$20 million Everest, behind only \$1.70 favourite Ka Ying Rising (Shamexpress).

Private Harry (Harry Angel), sent off the \$2.15 favourite after five undefeated starts, faded to fifth after looming early, with jockey Ash Morgan conceding: "I was under pressure a long way from home, I was flat from about the 350 metres."

Waller confirmed Joliestar will head straight to the Everest on October 18.

James saved some ground and it's a pretty quick track today." McDonald was glowing in his praise. "She's so good, I love her dearly. She's such a thrill to ride and every time she gives her

heart out there. She's a line chaser." Fangirl, who has now won nine of her 12 races at Randwick, will next defend her crown in the King Charles III Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) on October 18.



Jones cops suspension

Brisbane jockey Angela Jones has been suspended for 12 meetings after pleading guilty to a careless riding charge in Saturday's Sir Rupert Clarke Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Caulfield. Stewards ruled Jones, aboard Zarastro (I Am Invincible), shifted in at the 1200 metres and caused interference to Another Wil (Street Boss). Her ban begins September 28 and ends October 9. The race was marred by a fall involving Celine Gaudray, who was taken to hospital for observation after a head knock when Chorlton Lane (Mehmas) broke down in the straight. Gaudray, who walked back to scale, was stood down from her remaining rides. Chorlton Lane was humanely euthanised.

Back-to-back stakes wins for Tajana

Having landed the Northland Breeders' Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) on her previous start, the Shaune Ritchie and Colm Murray-trained Tajana (3 f Darci Brahma - Sleek Secret by Sakhee's Secret) made it successive stakes wins on Saturday when narrowly scoring in the Sunline Vase (Gr 3, 1400m) at Ellerslie. Ridden by George Rooke, the three-year-old filly defeated Lollapalooza (El Roca) by 0.1 lengths with a further 0.8 lengths back to Little Black Dress (Snitzel) in third place. "She is not a filly we expected to be firing over 1400 metres, so it really does look good going ahead with her," Ritchie said. "Isn't it great to have a couple of top-class fillies going head to head like that. It is good for racing so let's bring it on some more. She will now take her place in the Soliloquy Stakes back here and I really think Riccarton will suit her, but it is a hard race to win that [New Zealand] 1,000 Guineas."

Ears Back takes the Metric Mile

Evergreen seven-year-old Ears Back (7 m Jakkalberry - Makesmewonder by Grass Wonder) claimed a second career stakes win when proving 0.8 lengths too strong for her rivals in Saturday's Metric Mile (Gr 3, 1600m) at Trentham. The John Blackadder-trained daughter of Jakkalberry (Storming Home) was

ridden by Mereana Hudson and downed Knock Off (Fabulous), with a further 0.1 lengths back to Boomtown Boy (Caravaggio) in third. "This is probably the biggest thrill of my life, apart from family," Blackadder said. "I'm just absolutely ecstatic to be here and to win this race. She's just marvellous, and I think she's continuing to get better with age. She's just grown another leg. It was just brilliant today. I thought the other horse had a reasonably soft lead, but Mereana obviously knew what was underneath her. She gave her a great ride. I'd like to thank all the staff and all the owners. I'm just so proud of the horse and this win today really means a lot." The win added to Ears Back's maiden stakes success in the AGC Training Stakes (Listed, 1600m) at Wanganui in May.

Churmatt impressive at Ellerslie

Progressive colt Churmatt (Churchill) strengthened his New Zealand 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) credentials with a polished victory in the NZB Ready To Run Sale Trainers Series 3YO (1400m) at Ellerslie on Saturday. The \$2 favourite backed up his debut Rotorua win and Wanganui Guineas (Listed, 1200m) placing with another professional display under Opie Bosson. Settled behind the pace, Churmatt angled out in the straight before surging clear to defeat stablemate Swiss Prince (El Roca) by 1.8 lengths in 1:24.11. "Both of our two horses have gone well...it's nice when they can bring their good form to Ellerslie and that was what we were expecting," trainer Stephen Marsh said. "Both horses are nominated for the 2,000 Guineas. They are progressive and Swiss Prince will be very hard to beat when he gets back to a maiden." Raced by OTI Management alongside

Raptors Thoroughbreds, who secured him for \$80,000 at Karaka 2024, Churmatt has already shortened to \$8 third favourite for Riccarton's November classic. Bosson was glowing in his post-race assessment. "The draw helped and he relaxed beautifully for me," he said. "He has raw ability and is definitely one to watch." The win completed an early double for Marsh, following Well Written's (Written Tycoon) impressive debut in the previous race.

Diamond Jak delivers Ellerslie first

Diamond Jak (Jakkalberry) broke new ground at Ellerslie on Saturday, proving he is more than just a winter specialist with a gutsy victory in the \$65,000 Stella Artois (2100m). Previously unbeaten only on heavy going, the seven-year-old relished the Soft 5 conditions to snare his first win at Auckland's premier track - a milestone moment for owner-breeders Gary and Linda Hodel. "This will be a great thrill for the owners," trainer Mark Brosnan said. "They haven't had a win at Ellerslie before, so they'll be rapt to get one." Ridden positively by Matt Cameron after blowing the start in his previous outing, Diamond Jak settled closer and fought out a stirring three-way finish, edging Pacheco (Makfi) by 0.1 lengths with Quick Fire (Time Test) just another 0.3 lengths away in third. The victory took his record to six wins and \$234,725 in stakes. "Most of his form is on heavy ground, but he's shown today that he likes this better ground at Ellerslie too. That might open up some more options for him," Brosnan said.

Spencer back to winning form at Trentham

Quality winter sprinter Spencer (Derryn) returned to winning ways at Trentham on Saturday, proving just as effective on a better surface as in the depths of winter with a strong victory in the CR Grace Ltd & Waterforce Handicap (1200m). Prepared by Erin Hocquard, the six-year-old had endured a testing campaign, including a wide run when down the track in last month's Foxbridge Plate (Gr 2, 1200m). But a sharp trial win at Foxton during the week suggested he was ready to rebound, and he delivered on his favourite track where he has now won three of four starts.



With apprentice Sienna Brown utilising her four-kilogram claim to reduce his weight to 58kg, Spencer tracked the speed before powering clear at the 300 metres to score by a length over Bold Belle (The Bold One) on the Soft 6. "He has been a bit unlucky... nothing has really gone to plan like it did last year where it all just fell into place," Hocquard said. "Hopefully this will now give him a bit of confidence...I'm really happy as I was starting to wonder what it was like to have a winner." Bred and part-owned by Taranaki horseman Aidan Schumacher, Spencer has now won eight of 25 starts and just under \$280,000 in prize-money, his record headed by last year's Spring Sprint (Gr 3, 1400m) at Te Rapa.

Tardelli caps Ellerslie treble for Marsh

Spring racing lifted another gear at Ellerslie on Saturday, with Cambridge trainer Stephen Marsh walking away with three wins and a headline act in exciting entire Tardelli (I Am Invincible). After back-to-back victories from Guineas hopefuls Well Written and Churmatt, Marsh produced Tardelli first-up in the \$65,000 Eagle Technology (1400m) and the four-year-old didn't disappoint. Settled midfield by George Rooke, the son of I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit) loomed under a tight hold before sprinting clear for a two-length win over Cannon Hill (Ardrossan). "I was a passenger today," Rooke said. "He's really shown us what he's capable of...He's definitely a Group 1 horse." Marsh was equally taken. "He's a serious animal and has a lot ahead of him...I told George to just ride him like the best horse in the field, and if he's as good as we think he is, he'll do the rest." A winner of the Windsor Park Stud 3YO Trophy (1500m) last season and placed in Group company, Tardelli has now won three of 12 starts and looms as a major player in the summer features, with Marsh considering top-level targets.

Darley's former shuttler Blue Point (Shamardal) chalked up his 23rd individual stakes winner on Saturday when Samangan (2 c ex Samadrissa by Oasis Dream) landed the Prix Eclipse (Gr 3, 1200m) at Chantilly. Ridden by Mickael Barzalona for trainer Francis Graffard, the juvenile colt defeated Ceramic (Lope De Vega) by a half-length with a further four lengths back to Graft (US Navy Flag) in third. Bred and raced by the Aga Khan Studs, Samangan is out of the winning Oasis Dream (Green Desert) mare Samadrissa, making him a half-brother to fellow stakes winner Simeen (Lope De Vega). Samangan becomes the fourth stakes winner bred on the Blue Point / Oasis Dream cross and the cohort is headed by Group 1 winner Big Evs. Blue Point, who shuttled to Darley's Kelvinside base between 2020-2024, has not returned for the 2025 southern hemisphere breeding season. 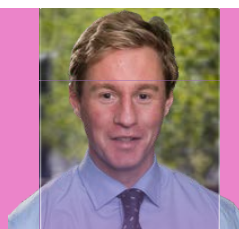
