# Charm Stone impressive in Manikato Stakes romp

harm Stone (I Am Invincible) advertised her spring credentials when she returned from a spell with a brilliant victory in Friday's Manikato Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) at The Valley, her second taste of Group 1 honours.

Having won the Sangster Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) against her own sex in Adelaide last season, the daughter of I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit) took the leap into open company in her stride, defeating last-start Moir

Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m) winner Baraqiel (Snitzel) by a cosy two lengths. Magic Time (Hellbent) was another 0.3 lengths further away in third.

Price said he was left scratching his head after Charm Stone made a second trip to Adelaide after her Sangster win when finishing in the second-half of the field in the Group 1 The Goodwood (Gr 1, 1200m).

"She's a mare that needs the edge on her,"
Price said. "I thought she was pretty right when
we ran her in The Goodwood last preparation,
but she said 'no I'm not very right' and got out
the back.



Price resorted to preparing the mare from his stables without the usual process of sending the mare to a pre-trainer.

He said Charm Stone had not put a foot wrong throughout her entire preparation.

"I've got to thank all the staff, we've got the East farm, the West farm," Price said. "They're all fantastic people.

"There was a little bit of speed in front of her, Blake got off the fence at the right time.

"She's a beautiful mare and it's so great to see her win another Group 1."

Shinn was celebrating his birthday on Friday and to win a Group 1 made it all the more special.

He said seeing former jockey Gary Willetts, who was associated with Manikato in the presentation area brought back a lot of memories.

"She was dominant," Shinn said. "She pinged the lids, got a great trail, and got out at the turn. She put the race to bed, and it was a phenomenal win."

From barrier two, Shinn said he went into Friday night's race with an open mind.

"We had a discussion pre-race to jump positive, have a little bit of intent for the first 50 [metres], and then just play it by ear," Shinn said.

"Looking at her replays, she's got very good gate speed and we wanted to utilise that, but then just ride the horse to run well."

A ten per cent share in Charm Stone was sold during the week for \$310,000 at the Inglis Digital September Sale which valued the mare at \$3.1 million.

After Friday night's success, that value is sure to have increased.

"You couldn't put a figure on what she'd be worth as a broodmare," Shinn said.

"But it's great for the breeding industry. It's great for people who are investing in the game."  $\,$ 

Bred by Emirates Park, Charm Stone was bought by Seamus Mills Bloodstock for \$1.55 million at the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale in 2022, making her highest priced filly sold at the auction that year.

The five-year-old mare is the third living foal of the brilliant dual Group 3 winner Najoom (Northern Meteor), who hails from the same family as Group 1 winners Criterion (Sebring), Comin' Through (Fastnet Rock) and four other stakes winners.

Now with two Group 1s to her name, Charm Stone is Najoom's second stakes victor, having emphatically eclipsed Listed-winning older sister Najmaty.

Najoom's yearling sister to Charm Stone fetched \$425,000 for Emirates Park when bought at Magic Millions Gold Coast this year by trainer Peter Snowden with Trilogy Racing and Suman Hedge Bloodstock.

A half-sister by Capitalist (Written Tycoon) was retained by Emirates Park after being passed in at Inglis Easter last year. Now named Nazwah, the filly broke her maiden at Gosford in July.

Najoom produced a colt by Emirates's co-owned stallion Tassort (Brazen Beau), who stands at Newgate Farm. Continued on page 3

#### West Of Swindon hands Coolmore's star-crossed stallion Wootton Bassett his first Australian stakes winner

The void Wootton Bassett's (Iffraaj) untimely death leaves in the global industry was drawn into stark focus on Friday when the stallion scored his first southern hemispherebred stakes winner courtesy of West Of Swindon's victory in the Stutt Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m) at The Valley.

The global industry was rocked on Tuesday when Coolmore's star recruit was euthanised while on shuttle duty in the Hunter Valley after the horse suffered from "acute pneumonia which deteriorated rapidly".

Wootton Bassett's impact in Australia has been a slow burner with the stallion siring ten winners in his first term, but was unlucky not to gain Group 1 laurels when his star son, Wodeton, finished a narrow second in the Golden Slipper (Gr 1, 1200m), while one of his other sons, State Visit, also finished runner-up in the highest company.

Despite being winless before Friday, West

Of Swindon was also stakes-placed as a juvenile, finishing second in the Silver Slipper Stakes (Gr 2, 1100m) last February when trained by Team Hawkes.

Switched to Ciaron Maher by his owner/ breeders Qatar Racing this season, the colt placed again at stakes level in Listed company on his second start this preparation.

Ridden by Ben Melham and trained by Ciaron Maher, West Of Swindon unleashed a potent turn of foot to beat Romantic Encounter (Ghaiyyath) by 0.4 lengths with Highvol (Microphone) another 2.3 lengths back to Hillier (Zoustar).

Maher believed the colt would be hard to beat on Friday and said he would now bid for Group 1 glory in the Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) on October 11.

"I was very confident, he's a high quality colt and he's beautifully bred. He might have been a maiden going into tonight, but I can't think of a better way to break that maiden," the trainer said.

"Onwards to the Guineas [Caulfield Group 1] now and I can't thank my team enough as

> they've done a great job with him and Ben Melham gave him a beautiful ride and took the race by the horns, made every post a winner and backed the horse, so fair play to him."

> Melham added: "He's a pretty wellcredentialed horse. He's been running in some better races in Sydney, around the best three-year-olds in Australia," he said.

> > "He's strong at the

mile, he's got a great attitude, he's got a good will to win for a colt, and he's got a good action, so that'll hold him in good stead."

Meanwhile, Matt Laurie's star colt Vinrock (I Am Invincible) suffered the second defeat of his career when he finished fifth in the Group 2, having been sent off the \$1.65 favourite.

His trainer Matt Laurie described the way the race panned out as a 'disaster'.

"He was meant to be forward and kind of blundered the start. It was pretty much a disaster. We will put a line through it and hopefully we can redeem ourselves in a couple of weeks," Laurie said.

The colt's rider Mark Zahra assessed the overall performance of Vinrock as "okay".

Zahra told RV stewards that it was his stated intention to lead or settle outside the leader but Vinrock dropped his head as the start was affected, losing ground.

He then said Vinrock over-raced and came close to clipping the heels of Bingi.

Zahra stated that Vinrock was under pressure from the 400m and he was reluctant to take him wide on the turn, instead he tried to improve on the inside of Bingi.

He said he was satisfied with the way Vinrock finished the race off.

Zahra told RV stewards that Vinrock raced at his best when he could settle closer to the lead.

Stewards later noted Vinrock was lame in the off foreleg.



# Freewheeling Jenni romps to Feehan Stakes victory

Pride Of Jenni (Pride Of Dubai) silenced any doubters that her best years were behind her when she defeated a small but select field of seasoned Group winners to retain her Feehan Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m) crown at The Valley on Friday night.

Having been retired and then returned to the racetrack, rumours of a second return to paddocks had been swirling around the Ciaron Maher-trained mare following her tenth-placed finish in the Doomben 10,000 (Gr 1, 2000m) last May. But she showed she was still worthy of being part of the conversation for the many of the big mile races this spring.

Ridden by regular partner Declan Bates, the eight-year-old took up her usual position at the front of proceedings, setting decent fractions on the lead.

When Matt Laurie's multiple Group 1-winning star Treasurethe Moment (Alabama Express) drew closer in the straight, Pride Of Jenni found more to gallop away with a 1.8-length victory over the daughter of Alabama Express (Redoute's Choice). Group 1 winner Attrition (Churchill) was another 3.7 lengths away in third.

"She's an amazing horse and Dec Bates knows her so well. Full credit to Tony for having the courage to race her on. She's 100 per cent sound. She's enjoying her racing," Maher said, who enjoyed a stakes-race double on the night.

"She just amazes me to do what she can do. Treasurethe Moment is such an elite horse and she can test the best of them on her day and she just amazes me."

The mare's owner Tony Ottobre described the mare as "just a champion".

"She's just a champion and we have great people around her to guide her to this. Ciaron is a superstar. To do this with an eight-year-old mare is unbelievable. The accolades must go to Ciaron for presenting the horse like this and Jenni is just a marvel," he said.

A \$100,000 Inglis Classic purchase from the Segenhoe Stud draft for Tony and Lynn Ottobre's Cape Schanck Stud, Pride of Jenni was bred by Trelawney Stud and is the best of two winners from winning O'Reilly (Last Tycoon) mare Sancerre, a daughter of Queensland Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) winner Vouvray.

# Snow Mercy takes big leap to win the Scarborough Stakes

Having shed her maiden status on her second start on her most recent appearance at Morphettville on September 13, the Phillip Stokes-trained Snow Mercy (Toronado) showed her talents when she added The Valley's Scarborough Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) to her CV on Friday.

Ridden by Lachlan Neindorf, the threeyear-old filly showed bravery in spades to beat Memo (Capitalist) by 0.8 lengths with another 0.1 lengths back to Point Barrow (Blue Point) in third.

Speaking post-race on behalf of his father and trainer, Tommy Stokes showed his admiration for the filly.

"She's shown a lot of promise with her data at home back in Adelaide, it's been super," said Tommy Stokes.

"To be honest, she couldn't have really done much more than she has in her two starts today. She probably should have won on debut, arguably, and second up she was super.

"She's been underdone for both of those runs too, and to come here third up on a big night.

"She's been prepped up really well by the team in Adelaide. Full credit to them, they do a great job, and I suppose the Adelaide form is always a bit discounted.

"She was super, she paraded really well, and aided by a really good ride by Lachie, summed up the race pre-race for us, and that's how it eventuated.

"So we're really rapt, and we might have to change our plans, although we were quietly confident going into the race, to win it is another thing, so we might have to choose a different way of getting to a better race now."

Confident that she is only going to improve, Stokes was enthused to secure some black type for the filly.

"We just wanted to get a bit of black type this preparation, and we know that she's going to be a better autumn horse," said Stokes.

"So, world's her oyster, and very good to kick off a group three winner, especially in these colours too. Instant Celebrity won in these colours, she won a [Group 1] Sangster. Really rapt for Trevor and Continued on page 5

Neindorf added: "She's a good horse. I've always had a big opinion of this filly from the early doors when I sat on her. I said to Tommy one morning, we've got something here and she just kept on going shin sore and minor issues.

"The team have been really patient with her and she's kept on coming back and showing us signs that she could reach this level.

"It's good to get her here tonight and a great

bunch of owners. It's a privilege to ride a winner in these colours. Obviously, going back to Instant Celebrity, she was a top-class sprinter, and she looks like she's going to follow in her footsteps."

Bred by Trevor and Beth Robertson, Snow Mercy is the best foal out of the placed mare Snow Surrender, who is a

half-sister to Listed winner Adelong (Medaglia D'Oro). Further afield this is the same family as Group 1 winner Snowland (Snippets) and Group 2 winner Portillo (Red Ransom), the dam of fellow Group 2 scorer Ghisoni (Lonhro).

#### 72 for Wootton Bassett

Coolmore's ill-fated shuttler Wootton Bassett (Iffraaj) scored his 72nd individual stakes winner and first in Australia when his son West Of Swindon (3 c ex Fife by Starcraft) landed the Stutt Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m) at The Valley on Friday. Purchased by his former trainers for \$350,000 at the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling from the Widden Stud draft, West Of Swindon is out of the winning Starcraft (Soviet Star), a half-sister Caulfield Cup (Gr 1, 2400m) winner Fawkner (Reset) and Tanby (Galileo), whose 11 wins were headed by two Group 2s. Wootton Bassett's global stakes winner now stands at 72 and they are headed by 16 Group 1 winners. Wootton Bassett was euthanised while on shuttle duty in the Hunter Valley after the horse suffered from "acute pneumonia which deteriorated rapidly".

#### 45 for Toronado

Swettenham Stud's sidelined stallion Toronado (High Chaparral) chalked up his 45th individual stakes winner when the Phillip Stokes-trained Snow Mercy (3 f ex Snow Surrender by Sepoy)

landed Friday's Scarborough Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) at The Valley. Bred by Trevor and Beth Robertson, Snow Mercy is the best foal out of the placed mare Snow Surrender, who is a half-sister to Listed winner Adelong (Medaglia D'Oro). Further afield this is the same family as Group 1 winner Snowland (Snippets) and Group 2 winner Portillo (Red Ransom), the dam of fellow Group 2 scorer Ghisoni (Lonhro). Snow Mercy's half-brother by Lonhro (Octagonal) was bought for \$110,000 at the Magic Millions Adelaide Yearling Sale and Snow Surrender produced a filly by Grunt (O'Reilly). Swettenham Stud's Toronado (High Chaparral) has been sidelined at stud duties for the 2025 season as he battles a significant infection. which in turn has caused him lameness.

#### 72 for Le Havre

Le Havre (Noverre) sired his 72nd individual stakes winner when Splash Back (6 m ex Tamazirte by Danehill Dancer) added a first stakes win to his record in the Stocks Stakes (Gr 2, 1500m) at The Valley on Friday. Trained by Grahame Begg, the mare defeated Abounding (Rich Enuff) by 0.8 lengths with another 0.3 lengths back to Molly Bloom (Ace High) in third. Purchased by Arthur Hoyeau and John Foote for €100,000 at the Argana October Yearling Sale in 2021, Splash Back is out of Group 2 winner Tamazirte (Danehill Dancer), making her a half-sister to dual Group 3 scorer Chachnak (Kingman) and Listed winner Into The Mystic (Galileo). "Her form has been sensational all the way through. Just needs the right scenario for things to work in her favour, and it was a great ride and great effort by the team," said Begg. "She needs a good run race and to be able to back off mid race and then she can tack up. 1500 metres is beautiful, that's her sweet spot distance range, and she's a very, very good mare. 'I know she's been going damn well. She only got beaten a length at Flemington the other day and came from near last, and we know she's in good form, and she's held her form well. She's a very good mare and a happy bunch of owners. She's so wellbred, this mare— a Group 2 win on the resume. It's outstanding."

#### Ryan confident Skyhook can feature in open Golden Rose

Gerald Ryan believes this year's Golden Rose Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) is one of the most open editions in recent memory, with seven of the nine runners priced at \$16 or under. "It wouldn't surprise me if any of them won it," Ryan said. "They're an even bunch of good horses... usually you get three chances in it and the rest are making up the numbers but I reckon this year there are nine chances." Among those is the Ryan and Sterling Alexiou-trained Skyhook (Written Tycoon), rated an \$6.50 chance after an eye-catching first-up victory in the Rosebud (Listed, 1100m) and a last-start third behind favourite Tempted (Street Boss) in the Run To The Rose (Gr 2, 1200m). It is the same program he gave Menari (Snitzel), who claimed the Rosebud-The Run To The Rose double in 2017 before finishing third to stablemate Trapeze Artist (Snitzel) in the Golden Rose when suffering a career-ending injury. "Menari was

unlucky because he pulled a shoe off and he was stuffed afterwards," Ryan said. "He never raced again. Trapeze Artist just kept going forward. They're all different but they all had good preparations going into it." The stable will also be represented in the Heritage Stakes (Listed, 1100m) by Farnan (Not A Single Doubt) pair King Of Pop and Grand Eagle. Ryan expects significant improvement from King Of Pop following the addition of blinkers and a favourable draw in the inside lane. "He's going to run heaps better ... he'll land in a good spot and people forget his last 600 metres was faster than Skyhook's [in the Run To The Rose]," he said. Grand Eagle will be looking to finish strongly ahead of a tilt at the Roman Consul Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) on October 11.

# Marhoona set for Heritage return

Michael Freedman's Golden Slipper (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Marhoona (Snitzel) is set to make her return in the Heritage Stakes (Listed 1100m) at Rosehill on Saturday. "She's probably a little stronger and more robust, she's never going to be a big rangy filly but she has some strength about her and she's in good nick," the trainer told Racing NSW. "One thing you don't have to worry about with a filly is whether they come back too colty which is always a bit of a question mark with the colts. She's always going to be a Group 1 winner now so from a future breeding perspective she has that in her back pocket. But Hussein Lootah, her owner, is quite keen to see her race on into the future and that's why we are giving her a lighter spring then into the autumn." Six of the youngsters that finished behind the filly in the Slipper line up in Saturday's Golden Rose, and Freedman said that while Marhoona has been absent, the form around her has been encouraging. "She had her first race start on February 7 so to be winning a Golden Slipper six or so weeks later is pretty amazing," he said. "She was there at the right time, in the right form, drew a good barrier. It was encouraging to see how Tempted came back from her two-year-old campaign. I've been very happy with her. You'd hope if she gets the right run, if she comes back in good enough form she'd be thereabouts for sure."

# Manaal set to continue spring resurgence in Golden Pendant

After an autumn where luck didn't go her way, the four-year-old posted her first win in a year in the Sheraco Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) and Freedman sees no reason why she can't continue on in winning fashion. "She was dogged by some pretty bad draws in the autumn but I still felt she was going well," he told Racing NSW. "It was nice to see her get an opportunity two weeks ago without any excuses. She's always been so honest and it was great to see her back in the winner's circle." Freedman said there are plenty of options for Manaal this spring, and she could be targeted at the Golden Eagle (1500m) via the Silver Eagle (1300m) or a race like The Invitation (1400m). "The 1400 metres is nice for her third-up, she seems to race well at Rosehill and I think it is a good option for her," he said. "If she can get the right run hopefully she can make her presence

#### Portelli confident Encap can peak on back-up

Encap (Capitalist) will follow a familiar path into next weekend's Epsom Handicap (Gr 1, 1600m) at Randwick, with trainer Gary Portelli hoping the gelding can again peak on a quick back up. The five-year-old produced a careerbest performance when running third in the Doncaster Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) just four days after finishing fourth in the Doncaster Prelude (Gr 3, 1500m), and he is set to back up seven days after tomorrow's Shannon Stakes (Gr 2, 1500m) at Rosehill. "He's got to back-up in the Epsom, which is what he did last time," Portelli

said. "I think I've done plenty at home to have him fit enough to be close to the mark. He has grown and matured and he's more burly, so this weekend will have him spot-on. We had a lot of problems with his feet last campaign. They've come good, we're not dealing with his sore feet anymore so that's going to help him too." Encap was due to resume in the Missile Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) in early August before the meeting was abandoned, leaving Portelli to 'play the catchup game' through trackwork, and the trainer's biggest focus now is on Encap's start, after he was slowly away when sixth in the Theo Marks Stakes (Gr 2, 1300m). "He just didn't begin and he couldn't make up any significant ground based on the fact the horses up front got home fast and it was a leaders' track on the day," Portelli said. "His sectionals read well, 33 and a bit [seconds] for the last 600 metres. I don't think he could have finished any closer on the times he ran but he can finish closer on the weekend if he jumps a bit better. If he jumps and he can be in a position where he used to be as a young horse, in the first four or five, then he's good enough to win the race."

# Rise At Dawn switched to Rosehill assignment

The Lindsay Park team of Ben, Will and JD Hayes will rely on Evaporate (Per Incanto) as their major chance in Saturday's Sandown Stakes (Gr 3, 1500m) after stablemate Rise At Dawn (Almanzor) was redirected to Sydney. A dual Listed winner, Rise At Dawn resumed with a strong third to Café Millenium (Not A Single Doubt) in the Tontonan Stakes (Listed, 1400m) at Flemington on September 13 and had been among the market leaders for the Sandown Stakes. However, connections opted to send him north for the Shannon Stakes, with the \$2 million Five Diamonds (1800m) firmly on the radar later this spring. "He's in great order and we're thinking the Five Diamonds might be a good race for him," Ben Hayes said. "He ran so well in the Doncaster going that way, and there's also the option of the Toorak." Meanwhile, Evaporate is back on track after a minor virus forced him out of the Sir Rupert Clarke Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Caulfield last weekend. A Stutt Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m) winner and Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) placegetter last season,

he returned this campaign with a fifth to Private Eye (Al Maher) in the PB Lawrence Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m). Hayes said he was encouraged by a recent trial and expects the gelding to thrive at Sandown. "We've taken the earmuffs off, he's drawn a barrier [ten] where he'll get galloping room, and I think you'll see the real Evaporate," he said. Stablemate The Pendragon (U S Navy Flag) also runs in the Sandown feature, with Lindsay Park expecting improvement secondup over the longer trip.

# Brown eyes Sandown with Von Hauke

Trainer Cliff Brown will be represented at Sandown on Saturday by Group 3 winner Von Hauke (Savabeel), who resumes in the Sandown Stakes. Von Hauke had his first start this preparation in late August before heading back to the jump-outs at Mornington. "He gave himself a freshen up, he played up going to the races the other day," Brown told Racing. com. "He's had a lifetime of always injuring himself, he's a master at it. He's really good; I'd like to get three or four runs where nothing goes wrong but I think he's in a good spot." The gelding is rated a \$31 chance in a competitive renewal of the Sandown Stakes. Brown is also coming off one of his biggest results since returning to Australian racing from Singapore, with Sepals (Caylx) landing last Saturday's Sir Rupert Clarke Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Caulfield. It was the trainer's first Group 1 success back on home soil. Sepals is now being aimed at the Toorak Handicap (Gr 1, 1600m) on October 11, again at Caulfield, though Brown said his participation will depend on how the four-yearold progresses. "He left a bit of feed on Saturday night and then Sunday he was out in the paddock...if he's ok, he'll go to the Toorak, but we'll just see how he is." Sportsbet rated Sepals at \$3.50 for the Toorak Handicap on Friday.

#### WA breeders backing Manhattan Rain's first local juveniles

Geisel Parkwon't be the only Western Australian farm represented when the first locally-bred two-year-olds by Group 1 sire Manhattan Rain (Encosta De Lago) step out this season. The former Arrowfield resident covered 68 mares in

his debut WA book, with notable support from David Reed, Greenfields Lodge, Rangeview Stud and Bellbridge Park.

Reed has four juveniles with Ravenswood trainer Tara Itzstein, who described them as "good-bodied with the right work ethic" and unlikely to be rushed early. He has a colt named colt Magnificent Mike, a half-brother to his dual stakes winner Magnificent Andy, the current favourite for the \$1 million Golden Saddle (1200m) in Kalgoorlie on October 4. Greenfields Lodge bred six Manhattan Rains, including a colt who is a brother to this year's Miss Andretti Stakes (Listed, 1200m) winner Man Crush, also set to contest the new Kalgoorlie slot race. Another filly they produced is the final foal of Group 1 -winning mare Juice (Bertolini). Both youngsters will join leading WA stables. A half-brother to Redoute's Choice (Danehill), Manhattan Rain stands at Geisel Park for \$5,500, alongside Aysar (Deep Field) (\$8,800) and Winning Rupert (Written Tycoon) (\$6,600).

#### De Armas stakes Karaka Millions claim with impressive debut win

Otaki trainer Johno Benner looks to have unearthed another Karaka Millions contender after exciting filly De Armas (Ardrossan) delivered an impressive debut victory at her home track on Friday. Benner, who won the Karaka Millions 2YO (RL, 1200m) with Vespa (Elusive City) in 2014 and the inaugural Karaka Millions 3YO Classic (RL, 1600m) with Scott Base (Dalghar) in 2018, was thrilled with the filly's professionalism in the Vets On Riverbank 2YO (800m). Backed into a \$1.70 favourite following a ten-length trial win at Foxton, she sat outside the leader before cruising clear for a 4.8-length success under Kelly Myers. "She has always shown plenty and has got above-average ability, but also a very good brain, which helps these young ones go a long way," Benner said. Purchased for \$16,000 at Elsdon Park's 2024 NZB Online Yearling Sale on Gavelhouse Plus, De Armas has already banked \$23,000 - a return that puts her on track to qualify for January's \$1 million Karaka Millions 2YO at Ellerslie.

Benner said she will now be freshened for the Wakefield Stakes (Gr 2, 1100m) at Awapuni in December, with a possible Ellerslie lead-up before the Millions. "The good ones take care of it for you," he said. "She definitely ticks a lot of the boxes that are required."

# The Scunner makes emphatic return at Otaki

Awapuni trainer Ashley Meadows' patient approach with The Scunner (Shamexpress) paid dividends at Otaki on Friday, where the sixyear-old announced himself as a rising openclass performer with a dominant first-up win in the Cavallo Farms & Chris Rutten Bloodstock Handicap (1400m). Carrying the minimum 54 kilograms, The Scunner was well-supported at \$4.60 on the back of a recent Foxton trial victory and delivered accordingly. Ridden by Samantha Collett, he settled midfield before cruising up to the leaders on the turn and sprinting clear to score by 4.5 lengths over Turn The Ace (Turn Me Loose) and Enrico (El Roca). "He's a really, really nice horse," Meadows said. "The ability has always been there, but we've given him time to mature and he seems to have come back a different horse this time in. His trial last week was great, so I was expecting a big run today." The Scunner has now won five of 13 starts, amassing over \$140,000. He broke through last season with three victories, including a Rating 75 (1600m) at Trentham in May, while earlier he claimed a \$65,000 event on New Zealand Cup Day at Riccarton. While a return to Christchurch in November remains an option, Meadows is keeping plans fluid. "We'll enjoy this win and let the dust settle, then decide where to head next," he said. The new father-and-son training partnership of Peter and Trent Didham struck their first success on Friday when Danjuro (Saxon Warrior) prevailed in The Tele Otaki Handicap (2100m). Trent became the fourth generation of the Didham family to train when the 27-year-old officially joined his father earlier this month, and the pair had quickly notched multiple placings before Danjuro delivered the breakthrough. Ridden by Kavish Chowdhoory, the five-year-old travelled sweetly in third before taking command on the turn and holding off King Khan (Mongolian Khan) by 0.2 lengths. "It feels good to get that first win, and it was a good tough effort by the horse," Trent Didham said. "His attitude has really picked up this time in. Hopefully he can go on with it." Danjuro now heads towards the Waverley Cup (2200m) on October 19. The Didhams will also have a strong hand at Waverley on Sunday. Promising filly Shameless Star (Shamexpress), fourth in the Manawatu Sires' Produce Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) last season, resumes in the NZB Mega Maiden Series (1200m) after a close second first-up at Wanganui. Victory would also secure a \$25,000 Karaka Millions bonus for connections. Stablemates Can Do (Contributer), a laststart placegetter now fitted with blinkers, and Felucca (Time Test), resuming off two trial wins, also line up on the card. "Her trials have been very impressive...I'm surprised she's opened at \$19," Didham said of Felucca, who lines up in Rating 65 (1200m) company.

# Miss Ziggy chasing maiden win

Stakes-performed filly Miss Ziggy (Brazen Beau) will attempt to shed her maiden tag in the Speight's Summit Ultra On Tap Maiden

(1400m) at Riccaton on Saturday. The daughter of Brazen Beau (I Am Invincible) has recorded five placings in her nine-start career so far, including a third place finish behind La Dorada (Super Seth) in the Karaka Millions 2YO at Ellerslie in January. The Andrew Carstontrained filly was beaten 4.2 lengths to finish fifth in the Canterbury Belle Stakes (Listed, 1200m) at Riccarton. "I was happy enough with her run in the Canterbury Belle," trainer said. "She's not helping herself by doing a few things wrong, which we're hoping to iron out. She'll run in the 1400-metre maiden on Saturday. I think that bit of extra distance will suit her. She'd have to be one of the better maidens in the country at the moment, and we'd like to get rid of that tag. This is probably D-Day for her - hopefully she'll give us a good showing and keep her spring campaign on track." Miss Ziggy is nominated for the New Zealand 1,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) on November 8 and the New Zealand 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) a week later.

## Carston plots carnival paths with Riccarton team

Andrew Carston will also unveil several carnival hopefuls at Riccarton on Saturday as his team gears up for November's New Zealand Cup week. Six-time winner Jon Ol Rocco (Time Test) resumes from a long layoff in the Join TAB Racing Club Mile Prelude (1400m), his first raceday appearance since December, with the gelding being being set for the Join TAB Racing Club Mile (Gr 3, 1600m) on November 12. "He's coming up really well," Carston said. "He trialled super and went to Timaru for a very good exhibition gallop. He's definitely going to need this run, he's been off the scene for quite a while, but it's a nice race to kick him off in and I'm very happy with the way he's going so far. At this stage, his campaign is centred around the big mile on the middle day of the carnival." Carston will also step out Ess Vee Are (Shocking), a former North Island stayer who made a promising stable debut when fourth over 1600 metres at Timaru on September 7. He rises to 2000 metres in the Waimakariri Businesses North Canterbury Cup as he heads towards the New Zealand Cup (Gr 3, 3200m). "That was a really pleasing first run for us," Carston said. "It was a big effort against a strong field and over a distance well short of his best. He's heading towards the New Zealand Cup and is showing us all the right signs so far. It's another strong field this weekend, but going up to 2000 metres suits and he seems like he'll only continue to get stronger and stronger as he builds towards the Cup."

# Harness colours carried by Yamato Satona on debut

The familiar harness racing colours of Barry and Katrina Purdon and Montana Park's Dean Shannon will be seen on three-year-old debutant Yamato Satona (Satono Aladdin) when he lines up at Te Rapa on Saturday. The \$250,000 Karaka purchase has been entrusted to Lance O'Sullivan and Andrew Scott and was given time to mature. "Barry was really keen to wait for him to turn three...he's a beautifully balanced colt and has come up very well this spring," Scott said. After five trials, including a strong effort at Rotorua on heavy ground, connections believe he can signal a bright future in the AM Roofing 1300 (1300m). Stablemate Kusuda Rush (Xtravagant) also resumes in the contest after a debut placing in the autumn and is expected to progress into better three-year-old races. Wexford has depth across the Te Rapa card, headed by Waitak (Proisir), who tackles the Howden Insurance Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) second-up. Scott expects the four-year-old to relish both the trip and softer conditions despite drawing wide. Meanwhile, She's All That (Time Test) resumes in the Amore Roses 1200 (1200m) after missing Taupo, and stakes winner I'munstoppable (Charm Spirit) returns in the Craigs Investment Partners Sprint (1100m). "She prefers going left-handed, so we think she'll put in a bold performance fresh," Scott said.

#### HK: Light Years Charm steps into stakes company for Celebration Cup

Light Years Charm (Rubick) will be tested in stakes company for the first time at Sha Tin on Sunday when he lines up in the Celebration Cup Handicap (Gr 3, 1400m). The David Eustacetrained gelding has climbed to a rating of 100 after a debut Hong Kong campaign in which he won four of nine starts, improving 36 points along the way. "He's gone through the grades really well," Eustace said. "His trials have been

good, everything's gone smoothly, so there'll be no excuses. But this is a different kettle of fish, so he needs to step up." Regular rider Zac Purton echoed Eustace's view: "He's going to need to raise the bar a little bit from what he's been doing," the champion jockey said. "He's not the easiest horse to ride, but David's managed him well and hopefully he continues to do so." Among his rivals is the Cody Motrained Markwin (I Am Invincible), a lightlyweighted improver who will carry 116lb under Harry Bentley. "He deserves his place," Bentley said. "He's up against some really handy types, but with the low weight I expect him to run well again." The Group 3 also features Group 1 scorer Victor The Winner (Toronado) who will look to improve on a lacklustre performance in the Chief Executive's Cup (1200m) first-up. Eustace has removed blinkers and steps the gelding up in trip. "I just want to see him travel at a 1400-metre pace and show he wants to do it," he said.

#### HK: Eustace test rising star Light Years Charm in Group debut

Light Years Charm (Rubick) steps into rarefied air at Sha Tin on Sunday when he competes in Pattern company for the first time in a mouthwatering feature race, the Celebration Cup Handicap (Gr 3, 1400m). The gelding has reached a career-high rating of 100 after a debut campaign in 2024/25 that saw him win four times. Trainer David Eustace is confident the five-year-old Australian import can give a good account of himself in the biggest race of his young career. "He's gone through the grades really well," Eustace said. "There was a bit of speed in his races, and as a result, he's been able to put in some good performances. His trials have been good. I've been happy with him. Everything's gone smoothly. So there'll be no excuses. He's beaten some nice horses along



Bred by Viktor Timoshenko and Andriy Milovanov, the filly was bought by Peter and Ross Doyle Bloodstock for €48,000 at the 2024 Arqana V2 session, before making €1,000,000 when selling to Stroud Coleman Bloodstock at the Arqana May Breeze-Up Sale the following year. Now raced by Victorious Forever, Zanthos is out of stakes-placed winner Brioniya (Pivotal), making her a half-sister to Listed-placed winner Bakhchisaray (Motivator).

#### 141 for Sea The Stars

Sea The Stars (Cape Cross) registered his 141st individual stakes winner on Thursday when Miss Alpilles (4 f ex Alma Linda by Invincible Spirit) landed the Jockey Club Rose Bowl Stakes (Listed, 2m) at Newmarket. Ridden by Kieran Shoemark for trainer Ed Walker, the four-year-old filly took a rearward position throughout the

two-mile contest before looming menacingly to East India Dock's (Golden Horn) outside approaching the furlong marker. Sent off a 20-1 chance, Miss Alpilles stretched clear of the son of Golden Horn (Cape Cross) to win by three and a half lengths, with Lavender Hill Mob (Expert Eye) finishing another two lengths back in third. Bred by Kirsten Rausing and Sunderland Holding Inc, Miss Alpilles was a 200,000gns purchase for Norris and Huntington out of Book 1 at the Tattersalls October Yearling Sale in 2022 and is now raced by John Pearce Racing. She is the first foal out of winning Invincible Spirit (Green Desert) mare Alma Linda, herself a half-sister to stakes winners Alla Speranza (Sir Percy) and Altesse (Hemando). The mare has since produced an unraced three-year-old filly named Alegria Mia by Sea The Moon (Sea The Stars) and a two-year-old colt named Arc Ole Ole by Study Of Man (Deep Impact). Sea The Stars stood the 2025 northern hemisphere breeding season for a fee of €250,000 (approx. AU\$446,775).
