Beiwacht emulates his father Bivouac with record-smashing Golden Rose win

The Chris Waller-trained Beiwacht emulated his sire Bivouac (Exceed And Excel) when winning Saturday's Golden Rose Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) in a record-breaking time, handing Godolphin a first Group 1 since the operation made the decision to switch to a public training model.

Beiwacht's time of 1:20.79 smashed the previous track record of 1:21.22 held by Cepheus

(Sea The Stars) leading to Waller to say he was 'humbled' to deliver Sheikh Mohammed's new-look set-up its first winner at the highest level.

Considered the third string of Waller's four runners in the Rosehill highlight, Beiwacht took up the running for Adam Hyeronimus and emphatically dispelled pre-race concerns over his ability to stretch to 1400 metres by running out a 4.1-length winner over stablemate Wodeton (Wootton Bassett), who delivered his fourth second-placed finish and second in the highest company.

Godolphin's other runner, filly Tempted (Street Boss), who came into the race off the back of a victory over Saturday's winner in the Run To The Rose (Gr 2, 1200m), was another 0.2 lengths away in third.

"Godolphin has been an amazing story for Australia and they've been my biggest competitor for so many years consistently in these big races, the stallion-making races," Waller said.

"We had four great colts in the race and unfortunately there is only one winner."

A winner of the Silver Slipper Stakes (Gr 2, 1100m) under the tutelage of James Cummings as a two-year-old, Beiwacht finished ninth in the Todman Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) and down the field in the Golden Slipper (Gr 1, 1200m), his final start as a juvenile.

Prior to his second-placed finish in the Run To The Rose, the colt opened his three-year-old preparation by running third in the San Domenico Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) at Rosehill in August.

Waller said he was confident the horse could make his Group 1 breakthrough, having continued to mature.

"We've had confidence the horse has continued to mature," Waller said. "What struck us the most today, he was so calm and relaxed. He is a proper racehorse."

"He's got good looks, he's got proper two-year-old form and he's backed it up at three."

Godolphin is yet to fill their slot for The Everest (Gr 1, 1200m) this year and managing director Andy Makiv said it is now between Beiwacht and Tempted.

"Three weeks in is a really good lead-up for either Beiwacht or Tempted to go back to the 1200 metres," Makiv said.

"They seem to be our logical choices and really our only choices."

In winning the 1400-metre contest, Beiwacht becomes Godolphin's seventh winner of the time-honoured Sydney Group 1, joining not only his father Bivouac, who won it in 2019, but an illustrious list of the operation's horses which includes last year's winner Broadsiding (Too Darn Hot) and Astern (Medaglia D'Oro).

Out of Sheikh Mohammed's homebred stakes winner Metastasio (Street Cry), Beiwacht is a half-brother to Listed winner Gravina (Sebring). The colt's second dam is Libretto (Singspiel), the dam of dual Group 1 winner Collette (Hallowed Crown).

Godolphin sold Metastasio for \$110,000 to Hirsch Racing at the Magic Millions Gold Coast National Broodmare Sale in 2024, when carrying a filly by Microphone (Exceed And Excel). She was most recently covered by Woodside Stud shuttler Benbatl (Dubawi).

Beiwacht is the headline act of three stakes winners for Darley's second-season sire Bivouac, whose total number of winners stands at 12. He is standing for a fee of an unchanged fee of \$55,000 (inc GST).

Ferivia punches Thousand Guineas ticket

Talented filly Ferivia (Astern) advertised her Group 1 credentials with a narrow but brave victory in the Thousand Guineas Prelude (Gr 2, 1400m) at Sandown on Saturday.

In a blanket finish in which a half-length separated the first five horses across the line, Ferivia prevailed by 0.1 lengths under Lachlan Neindorf from the \$2.80 favourite Ole Dancer (Ole Kirk) with Salty Pearl (Tagaloa) the same distance away in third.

Ferivia is in her first preparation of racing, having made her debut with a win over 1000 metres at Murray Bridge in July and won the Quezette Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) two starts later. She came into Saturday's contest off the back of a sixth-placed finish in the Atlantic Jewel Stakes (Listed, 1200m) on September 6.

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The filly was scratched on the morning of last weekend's Jim Moloney Stakes (Listed, 1400m) and Phillip Stokes described that twist of fate as a blessing in disguise, adding she would now head straight to the Thousand Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) at Caulfield on October 18 without another start.

Had Ferivia been able to start at Caulfield last week, Stokes said the filly would most likely have needed to line up in the Edward Manifold Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m) at Flemington next Saturday.

He said: "She was meant to run last week but we had to scratch her on race morning, but it has turned out to be a blessing."

"She missed a bit of work, so there is improvement to come and by the time the Guineas is run, she should be on song."

"I don't think the mile will be a problem. They really ran along, and she was strong late and I would like to think she could run out a strong mile."

"She does hit a flat spot and takes a while to wind up, but Lachie [Neindorf] knows her well."

Neindorf has always felt Ferivia would appreciate 1400 metres and is confident the mile trip in the Thousand Guineas will pose no issues for the filly.

"I thought I was gone at the 100 [metres], but she changed legs and found again," the rider said.

"She was tough. I've always said from day dot that she would be a 1400-metre to a mile horse, and I feel she's starting to make her presence felt."

"There was a good tempo, and she toughed it out late, and to be honest I felt I was only hitting my straps on the line."

"I think she'll get a mile for sure."

Ferivia is the third of five foals for Streetcar Express, who was a nine-start maiden in mostly country South Australia. Her dam, Streetcar Stella, managed to win a Balaklava maiden among eight starts.

Streetcar Express now has a yearling colt by Rich Enuff (Written Tycoon) and was covered last year by Flying Artie (Artie Schiller).

On the paternal side, Ferivia is one of eight Australian stakes winners for Astern, the 2016 Golden Rose (Gr 1, 1400m) hero, who's had a varied career as a stallion.

Astern shuttled five times to the USA for Darley, despite his Australian service fee dropping as low as \$16,500 (inc GST) in those years.

He hit the highs by siring two Australian elite winners in 2022-23, with Golden Mile claiming the Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) and Affaire A Suivre the SAJC Australasian Oaks (Gr 1, 2000m).

But ultimately Astern's successes were insufficient to keep him on the Darley roster, and he was exported last February to Turkey, where he stands for fee-on-arrangement.

Fine stakes double for Emirates Park, Freedman and Berry

Emirates Park, Michael Freedman and Tommy Berry enjoyed a terrific stakes double at Rosehill on Saturday courtesy of Marhoona's (Snitzel) victory in the Heritage Stakes (Listed, 1100m) and Manaal's (Tassort) triumph in the Pendant Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m).

Saturday's pair of success stories capped off a brilliant 24 hours for Emirates Park with the operation having also bred and sold Friday

night's Manikato Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Charm Stone.

The stakes brace was kicked off by Marhoona, who broke the so-called 'Golden Slipper' curse when she defeated Akaysha (Capitalist) by 0.7 lengths on her first start back from a spell, having not been seen since her impressive triumph in the coveted Rosehill juvenile Group 1 in March.

In winning Saturday's Listed race, the daughter of Snitzel (Redoute's Choice) became just the second Golden Slipper winner in the past eight years to add to her resume, with Fireburn, who won the juvenile Group 1 in 2022, the last winner to add another win to her record.

Berry admitted he was trying not to get ahead of himself ahead of her return given his experiences with previous Slipper winners Vancouver (Medaglia D'Oro), Overreach (Exceed And Excel) and Stay Inside (Extreme Choice), who all failed to go on as older horses.

"You know how well they're going at home but I have been tricked into two-year-olds coming back from winning a Slipper three times," Berry said.

"It's always in the back of your mind that they've got to come here and do it again."

The Roman Consul Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) is her likely next stop ahead of a tilt at the Coolmore Classic (Gr 1, 1200m) at Flemington.

"The plan was to come back here for the Roman Consul and then three weeks' into the Coolmore with a trial up the straight beforehand," Freedman said.

Marhoona is the sixth named foal of the 16-year-old Salma (Encosta De Lago) and is the best - in a hot field.

The mare's first foal, Trojan Harbour (Harbour Watch), was a Listed winner in South Africa, while her second named foal, Salateen (I Am Invincible), was a Listed winner and Group 2 placed. And next in line Hilal (Fastnet Rock) was a Group 2

winner who was placed at the top level.

Meanwhile, Marhoona's stablemate Manaal added Saturday's Group 2 feature to her victory in the Sheraco Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) a fortnight earlier and Freedman was thrilled to see her frank his opinion that she had only lost form during the autumn due to wide gates and bad luck.

"She was in the wilderness a little bit for eight or nine months and has come back from a disappointing run at Caulfield and then to win the Sheraco and back it up here today, it's a big thrill," Freedman said.

"I probably sound like a broken record but she has been going so well at home for quite a long time.

"It has been really frustrating going to the races previously where we've been hampered with bad barriers et cetera

"But I've always felt if she got the right run in a race she has still got plenty to give and you're never really sure with these mares as they start to get a little bit older."

Freedman will weigh up whether to freshen Manaal for the Silver Eagle (1300m) or head towards The Invitation (1400m) but says those two races shape as the "most logical options".

Manaal is out of the US-bred Listed winner Red Lodge (Midshipman), who Emirates Park picked up for \$500,000 at the Keeneland Breeding Stock Sale in 2018.

In 2023 Red Lodge produced a filly by Zoustar (Northern Meteor) and a colt by Justify (Scat Daddy) came the following year and missed to Tassort last season.

Emirates's co-own stallion Tassort (Brazen Beau), who stands at Newgate Farm. He commands a fee of \$38,500 (inc GST).

Darley's second-season sire Bivouac (Exceed And Excel) sired his first individual Group 1 winner when Beiwacht (3 c ex Metastasio by Street Cry) took out the Golden Rose Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Rosehill on Saturday. Second to fellow Godolphin-owned Tempted (Street Boss) in the Run To The Rose (Gr 2, 1200m) earlier in the month, the colt turned the tables on the Ciaron Maher-trained filly in emphatic style by running out a 4.1-length winner of the Group 1, beating Wodeton (Wootton Bassett) into second while Tempted finished just 0.02 lengths further adrift in third place. A homebred for Godolphin, Beiwacht is the seventh foal out of Listed winning Street Cry (Machiavellian) mare Metastasio, also the dam of the Group 3-placed Listed winner Gravina (Sebring). The mare is a half-sister to Australian Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) and Empire Rose Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Colette (Hallowed Crown). Bivouac is standing at Kelvinside for an unchanged fee of \$55,000 (inc GST).

Six for Trapeze Artist

Piggyback (5 m ex Wowie by Choisir) provided Widden Stud sire Trapeze Artist (Snitzel) with

his sixth individual stakes winner when she surged to victory in the Colin Stephen Quality (Gr 3, 2400m) at Rosehill on Saturday. The Ciaron Maher-trained mare enjoyed a dream inside run under Tim Clark, launching late to deny her stablemate and \$2.10 favourite Juja Kibo (Belardo) by 0.6 lengths. Taramansour (Dansili) was another 0.9 lengths back in third. Bred by Vieira Group Pty Ltd, who also bred and raced Trapeze Artist, Piggyback was initially a \$32,000 purchase for Louis Bloodstock out of Widden Stud's 2022 Magic Millions National Yearling Sale draft. Later that year she sold to owners Dynamic Syndications for \$27,000 through Magic Millions' September Online Sale. The first stakes winner out of Group 3-winning Choisir (Danehill Dancer) mare Wowie, Piggyback is a half-sister to multiple winner Karalee Rocks (Flying Artie). Trapeze Artist is currently standing for a fee of \$33,000 (inc GST).

Metropolitan plan for Piggyback

Piggyback is now under consideration for next weekend's Metropolitan Handicap (Gr 1, 2400m) after securing her first stakes win in the Colin Stephen Quality on Saturday. Rising sharply in grade from a Benchmark 78 (2200m) win in Queensland, the five-year-old mare was scoring her sixth career win from 17 starts. "It's the best she's ever presented and her last-start times suggested she was right on the up," Maher said post-race. "I thought Juja [Kibo] had a pretty good run, but 'Piggy' just out-toughed

him." Piggyback would carry just 50 kilograms in the Metropolitan and she could be joined in the Group 1 by her stablemate Juja Kibo.

14 for Awtaad

Derrinstown Stud stallion Awtaad (Cape Cross) registered his 14th individual stakes winner - and third in Australia - when Waterford (7 g ex Wake Up by Soldier Of Fortune) bounced back second-up to take out Saturday's Shannon Stakes (Gr 2, 1500m) at Rosehill. Tenth on resumption in the Tramway Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) earlier this month, the Chris Waller-trained gelding ran away with Saturday's Group 2, scoring by 2.3 lengths over Rise At Dawn (Almanzor), with just 0.04 lengths separating the runner-up from the third-placed Osipenko (Pierro). Waterford took his record over the 1500 metres at Rosehill to five wins and two placings from eight starts. Bred by Kildaragh Stud, the import is the third foal out of winning Soldier Of Fortune (Galileo) mare Wake Up making him a half-brother to Wagga Gold Cup (Listed, 2000m) winner Wicklow (Twilight Son). Awtaad stood the 2025 northern hemisphere breeding season for €7,500 (approx AU\$13,404).

Epsom option for Waterford

Waterford thrust himself into Epsom Handicap (Gr 1, 1600m) calculations with a dominant display in Saturday's Shannon Stakes at Rosehill, but trainer Chris Waller is leaning towards sticking to the original plan. The victory earned Waterford ballot exemption and penalty-free entry into next weekend's \$3 million contest



at Randwick, but Waller suggested the Alan Brown Stakes (1400m) in two weeks was the safer option – particularly with undefeated stablemate Autumn Glow (The Autumn Sun) looming as the Epsom's \$1.90 favourite. "There are some pretty influential owners in the horse who like to have their say, and I respect that," Waller said. "We'll see what they want to do, but otherwise he'll head to the Alan Brown, which is a good prize-money race too."

Toorak Handicap plan for Evaporate

Lindsay Park's talented four-year-old Evaporate (4 g Per Incanto - Savanna by Animal Kingdom) overcame a mid-prep hiccup to land Saturday's Sandown Stakes (Gr 3, 1500m) at Sandown-Hillside, holding off favourite Transatlantic (Snitzel) in a thrilling finish. Carrying 59 kilograms and caught wide early, jockey Blake Shinn made a bold mid-race move to roll forward aboard the gelding. He responded gamely after controlling the tempo, digging deep in the final stages to hold off Transatlantic by 0.06 lengths and take his career earnings past \$1.59 million. "It was a very good effort by the horse," co-trainer Ben Hayes said. "He had a setback, trialled well, and Blake made the right move at the right time. He's always been an exciting horse and he's put his hand up for the Toorak Handicap." Shinn praised the gelding's competitive instincts. "He's a bold, arrogant horse who likes to roll," he said. "You can't fight him—you have to go with him. The plan worked out, and he showed his class." Already a Group 2 winner, Evaporate's record now boasts six wins and five placings from 16 starts. Bred by Little Avondale Stud, he is by their resident sire Per Incanto (Street Cry) out of Savanna (Animal Kingdom) – a half-sister to Bjorn Baker's Group

3 winner Belluci Babe (Per Incanto), Evaporates three-quarter sister. Purchased by Lindsay Park for \$330,000 from the Sledmere Stud draft at the 2023 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale, Evaporate will next target the Toorak Handicap (Gr 1, 1600m) at Caulfield on October 11.

Stakes aim for Aleppo Pine

Godolphin colt Aleppo Pine (Blue Point) signalled a return to form with a determined victory in Saturday's Sportsbet Feed Handicap (1000m) for three-year-olds at Sandown Hillside, his first win since switching from James Cummings to Lindsay Park. Ridden by Beau Mertens, the \$2.45 favourite settled just behind the pace before knuckling down to wear down Cannyworth (Written Tycoon) by a half-length, with stablemate Shining Smile (Spirit Of Boom) running on into third, another 3.2 lengths back. Fifth in the Blue Diamond Prelude (Gr 3, 1100m) (C&G) in February, Saturday marked Aleppo Pine's second win from six starts, adding to an earlier stakes placing in the Redoute's Choice Stakes (Listed, 1100m). "I think we'll see how he pulls up and look for a suitable Stakes race in a few weeks," co-trainer Ben Hayes said. "Today was about getting him to relax, and he did that. It's great that he can remain a colt." By Darley's Blue Point (Shamardal), Aleppo Pine is out of the Redoute's Choice (Danehill) mare Retsina, making him a half-brother to stakes winners Athiri (Lonhro), Savatiano (Street Cry) and Vilana (Hallowed Crown). Blue Point shuttled to Darley's Australian base for five seasons, but did not return this year.

38 for Dundee

Arrowfield Stud resident Dundee (High Chaparral) chalked up his 38th individual stakes winner on Saturday when Tavs (5 g ex Quattro Foglie by Beneteau) won the Weetwood Quality (Listed, 1200m) at Toowoomba. Trained by Mark Currie and ridden by Angela Jones, the five-year-old gelding defeated Nettuno (I Am Invincible) by an impressive 4.6 lengths with another 1.3 lengths back to Sha Of Gomer (Shalaa) in third. Bred by Galletta Construction, the gelding is out of dual winner Quattro Foglie (Beneteau). Dundee is standing for an unaltered fee of \$88,000 (inc GST).

New Zealand

12 for Satono Aladdin

Magic Carpet (3 c From Eden by Tavistock) provided Rich Hill Stud sire Satono Aladdin (Deep Impact) with his 12th individual stakes winner when he shed his maiden tag in Saturday's Hawke's Bay Guineas (Gr 2, 1400m) at Hastings. The Stephen Marsh-trained three-year-old colt forced a gap under Jonathan Riddell at the 300 metres and surged clear before repelling the persistent Quondo (Wootton Bassett) to score by 0.8 lengths. Faultless (Tivaci) was the same margin further behind in third. Bred by Jenna McLeod, her brother Brian and parents Philip and Jackie Rogers out of their Tavistock (Montjeu) mare From Eden, Magic Carpet is closely related to Australian Group 2 winner The Fuzz (Danasinga) and Thorndon Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Stolen Dance (Alamosa). He was purchased for \$320,000 by Marsh and bloodstock agent Dylan Johnson out of the Carlaw Park draft during the Book 1 sale at Karaka in 2024. Satono Aladdin is standing at Rich Hill for a fee of \$45,000 (plus GST).

Magic Carpet flies to impressive Guineas victory

Cambridge colt Magic Carpet delivered on his early promise in perfect fashion at Hastings on Saturday when breaking his maiden in the Hawke's Bay Guineas. "We had to ride him upside down last time at Taupo and I thought Jonathan [Riddell] would be someone who would really suit this horse as he is a good, strong rider," Marsh said. "He got the best out of him as he just loped along when he hit the front. He has plenty of upside and is just a lovely horse." Placed at his first two starts, Magic Carpet is now firmly on a path to the New Zealand 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m), with a likely lead-up in the Sarten Memorial (Gr 2, 1400m). TAB bookmakers installed him a \$10 chance for Riccarton's November 15 classic, where Hostility (I Am Invincible) and He Who Dares (Snitzel) share \$6 favouritism.

Alottago aces Guineas audition

South Island colt Alottago (Tagaloa) threw his hat firmly into the New Zealand 2,000 Guineas ring with a powerful last-stride win in the Guineas Trial (1400m) at Riccarton on Saturday. The Lance



Robinson-trained gelding had shown talent as a juvenile with three stakes placings, and he's now unbeaten in two starts at three. Patiently ridden by Corey Campbell, Alottago produced a devastating turn of foot to swamp War Of Silence (Snitzel) and score by 0.1 lengths, with Pontoon (Ace High) a distant third. "He's such a relaxed, laid-back horse, and when you ask him to go, he can really sprint," Campbell said. Robinson, who part-owns the \$20,000 Ready to Run purchase, was delighted with the effort and confirmed Riccarton's classic on November 15 is the target. "This win has given us the confidence to carry on that path for now," he said. "He was impressive and has always been a horse we've liked. The step up to 1400m really suited." Alottago shortened from \$31 to \$16 for the 2000 Guineas following Saturday's success. A tilt at the Barneswood Farm Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) later this month is under consideration as his next step.

Whiskey 'N Roses makes winning return

Whiskey 'N Roses (4 g Belardo - Fullinbloom by Fully Fledged) launched a devastating late sprint to score first-up in Saturday's BCD Group Sprint (1200m) at Te Rapa. Prepared by Joanne Surgenor, the gelding had shown smart three-year-old form last season - finishing runner-up to Savaglee (Savabeel) in the James & Annie Sarten Memorial Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) - and he resumed in style with a barnstorming performance under Joe Doyle. Settled last in the early stages as favourite Midnight Edition (Wrote) controlled the tempo, Whiskey 'N Roses circled widest and swept past the leader inside the final 100 metres to score by 0.8 lengths in 1:13.20 on a Heavy 9 track. "I said to Joe if we just sat back and didn't get into a speed duel he normally finishes things off well," Surgenor said. "I was hoping for a good run but I didn't expect that - he's a lot stronger now and just keeps improving." Bred and co-owned by Peter and Sherin Walker with Haunui Farm, Whiskey

'N Roses is the first foal out of Fullinbloom (Fully Fledged), a daughter of multiple stakes winner Rodrigo Rose (Rodrigo De Triano).

Stonybreck runaway caps Riccarton treble for Te Akau

Te Akau made their presence felt at Riccarton on Saturday with a dominant treble, headlined by a brilliant performance from seasoned campaigner Stonybreck (Tavistock) in the Join TAB Racing Club Mile Prelude (1400m). The gelding, a \$20,000 Karaka 2021 Book 1 purchase, was perfectly rated by Jasmine Fawcett and simply ran his rivals into the ground, streaking clear to win by five lengths in a slick 1:21.76. It was the eight-year-old's eighth win from 30 starts and took his earnings past \$170,000. Earlier in the day, Snitzel (Redoute's Choice) filly Origin Of Love booked herself a potential New Zealand 1,000 Guineas campaign with a determined neck victory in a 1400-metre maiden contest, and the tangerine colours were also carried to success by precocious juvenile Out Of The Blue (Tivaci), who proved too sharp in the Nobby Bussell Memorial 2YO (800m). Out of Te Akau's former stakes-winning mare Cornflower Blue (Savabeel), he was another astute Karaka Book 1 buy and is now safely qualified for the Karaka Millions in January. "It was a terrific day," Walker said. "Stonybreck has thrived since coming south, Origin Of Love looks an ideal Guineas filly, and Out Of The Blue gives us another exciting two-year-old heading towards the Karaka Millions."

Williams brings up career milestone with dramatic North Canterbury Cup victory

Kylie Williams reached a cherished milestone at Riccarton on Saturday, bringing up her 1000th career win when guiding Riviera Rebel (Pure

Champion) to victory in the North Canterbury Cup (2000m). The South Island jockey had earlier moved to 999 wins with success aboard Miss Ziggy (Brazen Beau) in the opener, before striking gold later in the day on the Graham Eade and Brooke Kincaid-trained five-year-old. Riviera Rebel, already a proven performer at Riccarton, showed his trademark grit to fight off Moussaieff (Redwood) and the late-finishing Elegant Lady (Highly Recommended) to notch his seventh career win by 0.8 lengths. The result carried a bittersweet edge, however, after a fall at the 600 metres brought down four horses and riders, with others badly hampered. Several jockeys, including Brandon May, Bridget Grylls and Jack Taplin, were taken to hospital for assessment, while all horses were reported to have escaped with only minor knocks. The final two races on the card were subsequently abandoned. For Kincaid, Riviera Rebel's toughness was again on show. "He's been such a good horse for us," she said. "He gave me my first training win, our first stakes win in the Canterbury Gold Cup, and now he's given Kylie her 1000th winner. He just fights so hard when he gets to the front, he doesn't want to let anything past him."



11 for Roses In May

Ho O Roulette (6 h ex Omega Fragrance by Gold Allure) landed The Sirius Stakes (Gr 3, 2000m) at Hanshin on Saturday and in doing so became the 11th individual stakes winner for his late sire Roses In May (Devil His Due). Trained by Toru Kurita, the six-year-old defeated Saimon Xanadu (Asia Express) by half a length with another nose back to June Aoniyoshi (Kizuna) in third. Ho O Roulette is out of three-time winner Omega Fragrance (Gold Allure) making him a half-brother to Omega Perfume (Swept Overboard), winner of the Ohi Tokyo Daishoten (Gr 1, 2000m) a mighty four times. Roses In May died earlier this year.

HK: Romantic Warrior shines in Happy Valley trial

The 2023 Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) winner Romantic Warrior (Acclamation) took an important step towards a high-profile return



when finishing fourth in a 1700-metre barrier trial at Happy Valley on Friday. Ridden by Hugh Bowman in the absence of James McDonald, the ten-time Group 1 winner closed off stylishly under little pressure behind Awesome Fluke (Shamus Award), pleasing trainer Danny Shum as he builds towards a record-extending fourth Hong Kong Cup (Gr 1, 2000m) at Sha Tin on 14 December. Sidelined since a fetlock surgery in May, Romantic Warrior is scheduled to resume in the Jockey Club Cup (Gr 2, 2000m) on November 23 before defending his Hong Kong Cup crown and then heading back to the Saudi Cup (Gr 1, 1800m) in February. "I'm very happy with him," Shum said. "He's been galloping well, eating well. The plan is the Jockey Club Cup, then December, then Saudi - that's the plan." Bowman was similarly satisfied: "He was a bit keen early but relaxed into a really good rhythm. The last 400 metres he worked up within himself and his action felt great. He'll improve from this." The world's highest-earning racehorse with HK\$214.7 million (AU\$42,145,610) in prize-money, Romantic Warrior has not raced since his Dubai Turf (Gr 1, 1800m) second in April.

International

Nine for Mehmas

Tally-Ho resident Mehmas (Acclamation) sired his ninth individual Group 1 winner when his son Wise Approach (2 c ex Sagely by Frozen Power) produced a remarkable performance to land the Middle Park Stakes (Gr 1, 6f) at Newmarket on Saturday. The Charlie Appleby-trained colt stumbled coming out of the gates, forcing William Buick to take the patient approach at the back of the field. As the field approached the dip, Buick asked Wise Approach for his effort and he responded in fine style to beat Brussels (Wootton Bassett) by three-quarters of a length. Coppull (Bated Breath) was a further short-head away in third. Bred by Tally-Ho, Wise Approach was purchased by his owners Godolphin for a cool 1,000,000gns at Book 1 of the Tattersalls October Yearling Sale in 2024 and he is a half-brother to dual Group 1-winning sprinter Perfect Power (Ardad) and the stakes-placed winner



True Love

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Ten for No Nay Never

After finishing a disappointing second behind Power Blue (Space Blues) when sent off the hot-favourite in the Phoenix Stakes (Gr 1, 6f) last month, the Aidan O'Brien-trained True Love (2 f ex Alluringly by Fastnet Rock) made amends on Saturday when she triumphed in the Cheveley Park Stakes (Gr 1, 6f) at Newmarket, handing Coolmore stallion No Nay Never (Scat Daddy) his tenth elite-level winner in the process.

Ridden by Wayne Lordan, the filly travelled smoothly throughout the mile contest, eventually crossing the line three quarter lengths clear of Havana Anna (Havana Grey). Royal Fixation (Palace Pier) was another length further adrift in third.

True Love was originally cut to 16-1 (from 25) by Paddy Power for next year's English 1,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1m), before they shortened her again to 12-1.

Winning rider Wayne Lordan told ITV Racing: "We won't know if she'll stay a mile until next year, but she has plenty of speed. She coasted past the furlong and found plenty for pressure.

"She finished second last time, but she's matured and grown stronger since then. She keeps on changing, so you just won't know what will happen. We see her every day at home, but when I got up on her, I realised then how big she's getting. She's growing into herself and still improving."

The filly adds his latest win to her CV to go with her victories in the Queen Mary Stakes (Gr 2, 5f) and Railway Stakes (Gr 2, 6f).

Bred and raced by Coolmore, True Love is out of Alluringly, a Listed-winning daughter of Fastnet Rock (Danehill) who was also third in the Epsom Oaks (Gr 1, 1m 4f). She has produced two further winners, headed by True Love's Group 2-winning sister, Truly Enchanting and Lily Pond (Galileo), whose two wins are headed by a victory in Group 2 company at the Curragh.

Alluringly is out of the unraced mare All For Glory (Giant's Causeway), herself out of the Group 2 winner All Too Beautiful (Sadler's Wells), who finished runner-up in the Oaks in 2004.

All Too Beautiful is the dam of Listed winners Victory Song (Dansili) and Wonder Of Wonders (Kingmambo), who, like her dam, finished second in the Oaks and produced fellow stakes winner So Wonderful (War Front).

A daughter of Sadler's Wells (Northern Dancer), All Too Beautiful is also the dam of the stakes-placed Sparrow (Oasis Dream), who in turn produced Sir Dragonet (Camelot), whose two Group 1 victories include a win in the Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m), Group 2 scorer Les Pavots (No Nay Never) and dual Australian Listed winner Sir Lucan (Camelot).

No Nay Never stood for a fee of €125,000 (approx. AU\$220,826) in 2025.



Golden Mind (Galileo Gold). Further back this is the same family as Australian Group 3 winner Protagonist (Wootton Bassett). Wise Approach - who finished third in the Prix Morny (Gr 1, 1200m) last month - was introduced at 20-1 for next year's English 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1m) with Paddy Power after registering his third win of the season.

73 for Wootton Bassett

Less than a week after his untimely death, Wootton Bassett (Ifraaj) continued to make his legacy felt when he was supplied with his 73rd individual stakes winner courtesy of Hawk Mountain's (2 c ex Hydrangea by Galileo) impressive win in the Beresford Stakes (Gr 2, 1m) at the Curragh on Saturday. Bred and raced by Coolmore, the Aidan O'Brien-trained colt was not for catching in the Group 2 contest, scurrying home to defeat Geryon (Lope De Vega) by three and a quarter lengths. Al Haarith (Lope De Vega) finished a further head away in third. Bred in the purple, Hawk Mountain is out of dual Group 1 winner Hydrangea (Galileo), making him a half-brother to stakes-winning duo Officer (Dubawi) and Wingspan (Dubawi). Hydrangea is out French Group 2 scorer Beauty Is Truth and she is also the dam of, among others, Ranvet Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) winner The United States (Galileo) and Hermosa (Galileo), who in turn produced Hampton Court Stakes (Gr 3, 1m 1f) winner Trinity College (Dubawi). Hermosa is notably also a sister to Salsa (Galileo), the dam of dual Group 1 winner Whirl (Wootton Bassett). Hawk Mountain is yet again a timely reminder of the

potency when Wootton Bassett is crossed with daughters of Galileo (Sadler's Wells), with the colt becoming the tenth stakes winner bred on the nick. This latest stakes winner comes hot on the heels of West Of Swindon, who won the Stutt Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m) at The Valley on Friday to become Wootton Bassett's first southern hemisphere-bred stakes winner. The stallion was sadly euthanised on Tuesday while on shuttle duty in the Hunter Valley after suffering from "acute pneumonia which deteriorated rapidly".

UK: Bow Echo remains unbeaten

The George Boughey-trained Bow Echo (2 c Night Of Thunder - Aristocratic Lady by Invincible Spirit) kept his unbeaten record intact when he landed the Royal Lodge Stakes (Gr 2, 1m) at Newmarket on Saturday. Ridden by Billy Loughnane, the colt followed up his recent win in the Ascendant Stakes (Listed, 1m) by beating Humidity (Ulysses) by a length. Action (Frankel) finished a further half a length away in third. A homebred for Sheikh Mohammed Obaid Al Maktoum, Bow Echo is the second foal out of the winning Invincible Spirit (Green Desert) mare Aristocratic Lady, herself a half-sister to Group 3 winner Royal Rhyme (Lope De Vega) being out of a winning half-sister to Dubawi (Dubai Millennium). Night Of Thunder, who shuttled to Australia for one season in 2016, stood the 2025 northern hemisphere breeding season at Kildangan Stud for a fee of €150,000 (approx. AU\$268,230) and

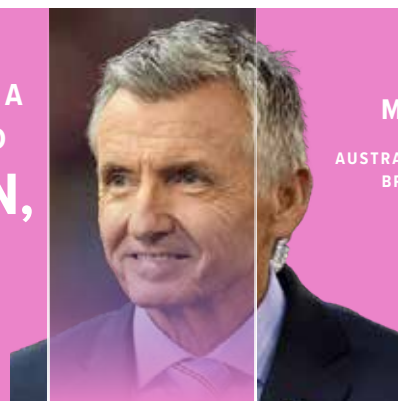
he is currently sitting atop the British and Irish stallion standings.

UK: Breeders' Cup winner Unquestionable to stand at Rathbarry Stud next year

Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf (Gr 1, 8f) winner Unquestionable (Wootton Bassett) will stand at Rathbarry Stud next year, the County Cork-based operation has announced. A son of the late, great Wootton Bassett, who died earlier this week, Unquestionable was one of the best juveniles by his sire, with his six-race campaign that year culminating in victory at the Breeders' Cup at Santa Anita. Trained by Aidan O'Brien, Unquestionable was third on debut in Listed company that May and readily broke his maiden by four and a quarter lengths next time out at the Curragh. He went on to finish a narrow second to another son of Wootton Bassett in Bucanero Fuerte in the Railway Stakes (Gr 2, 6f) and, following his fourth-placed effort in the Phoenix Stakes (Gr 1, 6f), ran Rosallion (Blue Point) a close second in the Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere (Gr 1, 1400m) at Longchamp. He rounded off that campaign with a clear-cut success in the Juvenile Turf. Rathbarry's Catherine Cashman said: "His sire line and his dam line are capital while everyone loves Sea The Stars, who is beginning to establish himself as a good broodmare sire. It is one of the famous Best In Show lines, a very good female line. He was a very good two-year-old and he ran well on both his starts at three, he was fourth to Rosallion on both occasions, who was a top three-year-old last year."

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Waitak surges past \$1 million mark with Howden Mile triumph

Saturday's Howden Insurance Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) at Te Rapa took Waitak (6 g Proisir – Repo Bay by Shocking) past the \$1 million barrier and added another triumphant chapter to his unique Group 1 record.

The \$400,000 weight-for-age showpiece was Waitak's 12th appearance at Group 1 level. Those dozen races have been spread across his two, three, four, five and now six-year-old seasons, and they have ranged from 1200m metres all the way up to 2400 metres.

Before Saturday, Waitak's career highlight came with his stunning burst from the back of the field to win the Sistema Railway (Gr 1, 1200m) in January of 2024, backed up by highly creditable performances to finish third in the Manawatu Sires' Produce Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m), fourth in the BCD Group Sprint (Gr 1, 1400m), and fifth in the New Zealand Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) and Tarzino Trophy (Gr 1, 1400m). The Proisir (Choisir) gelding also completed a feature autumn double earlier this year in the Japan Trophy (Gr 2, 1600m) and Awapuni Gold Cup (Gr 2, 2100m).

But if Saturday's superb come-from-behind defeat of five other Group 1 winners is anything to go by, there could still be much more to be

written about Waitak.

"This is amazing," said Andrew Scott, who trains in partnership with Lance O'Sullivan. "It's great for the horse and great for Team Devine [owner Jill Devine, whose late husband Colin bred Waitak].

"The team has been so confident with this horse all week. He galloped the house down on Wednesday morning and he's just kept improving.

"It's all about getting him to relax and settle in his races. When he does that, he's got such a wicked turn-of-foot.

"He's been very lightly raced and has just turned six. We said at the start of the season that this will be his best year. Not a lot has really gone his way in the last couple of years. Hopefully he can get the momentum going now.

"He's just such a wonderful racehorse. To win two Group 1 weight-for-age races is amazing. He's a marvel for our stable and a pleasure to train. He's just a star."

Waitak never saw daylight when he resumed with a luckless 11th in the Proisir Plate (Gr 1, 1400m) at Ellerslie earlier this month. If he was going to turn his luck around in the

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Howden Insurance Mile at Te Rapa on Saturday, he would have to do it from the extreme outside gate in a 14-horse field.

But jockey Craig Grylls rode a patient race, giving Waitak time to find his feet and settle into a smooth rhythm in fifth-last position.

The favourite La Crique (Vadamos) went for gold at the top of the home straight, bursting to the lead with a powerful kick. She quickly went two and three lengths clear of nearest rivals Sterling Express (Shamexpress) and Legarto (Proisir).

But then Grylls unleashed Waitak, who roared down the outside, devouring La Crique's advantage and sailing past her in the final few strides. Waitak went on to win by a half-length, with La Crique second and Ladies Man (Zed) an eye-catching third ahead of Sterling Express and Legarto.

Waitak delivered a third win in the race for Grylls, who had previously been successful aboard Pure Champion (Footstepsinthesand) (2014) and La Crique (2022). Those three wins have come at three different venues, with Pure

Champion winning at Hastings, La Crique at Matamata and Waitak at Te Rapa.

"I won this race in the same colours with Pure Champion 11 years ago, so it's great to do it again," Grylls said. "I'm really grateful to Lance and Andrew for putting me on the horse.

"He was luckless last time, but we got a perfect run today from the outside gate. There was good speed on and we worked into the race at the right time.

"He had a horse to chase in La Crique. I was pretty confident from about 100 metres out that we'd pick her up, because he had all the momentum.

"He's a good horse. He's shown that over the years, and today has just cemented that again."

Scott confirmed that Waitak will now be set for the Livamol Classic (Gr 1, 2040m) at Ellerslie on October 18.

"These were the races we set him for when we brought him up for the spring," he said. "Hopefully, with a bit more improvement from his second-up run today, he'll be competitive

again in the next one. But for now we'll just celebrate this win. It's an amazing result."

Waitak's 33-start career has now produced seven wins, nine placings and \$1.2 million in prize-money.

Incredibly, the Howden Insurance Mile was La Crique's eighth runner-up finish in a Group 1 race and her sixth in a row.

"It's a little bit frustrating, but at least we've won Group 1 races with her as well," co-trainer Katrina Alexander said. "It would be much worse if we were getting all these placings without having won one.

"We're proud of her. She's ultra-consistent and always delivers. She's never let us down.

"We have tentative plans to fly her to Sydney next weekend to target the Hill Stakes [Gr 2, 1900m] at Rosehill. We think the conditions and distance of that race will suit her, and it would be great for her connections [owner-breeders John and Jan Cassin] if she could put her foot in the till in good company in Australia."

The Hill Stakes will be run for a stake of A\$2 million on October 11.

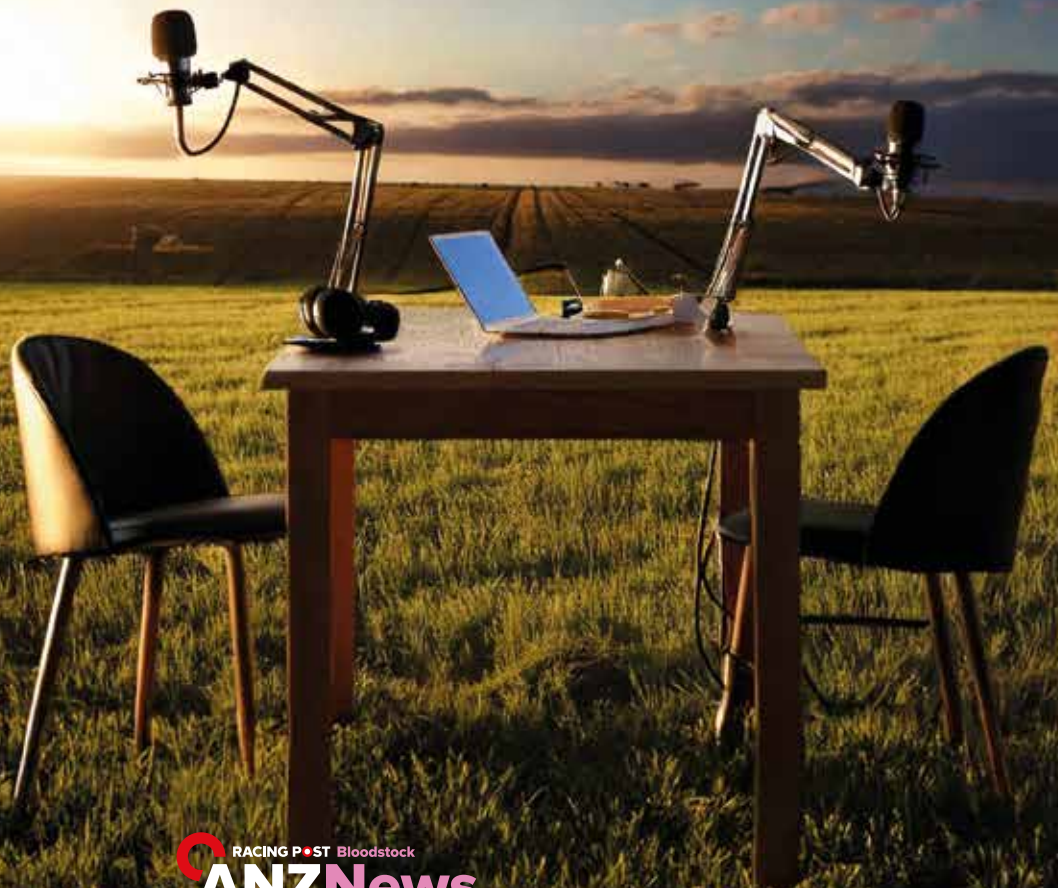

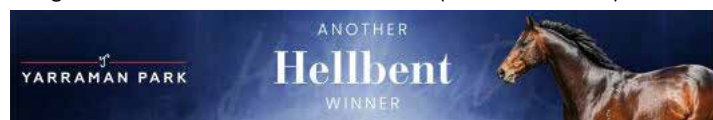

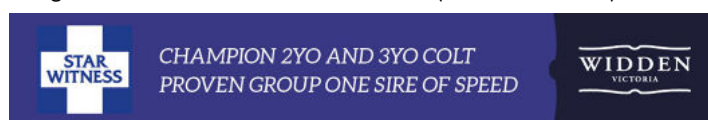
