Autumn's the Boy as he continues Guineaswinning family trait

n a full-circle moment for his trainer Chris Waller, Autumn Boy (The Autumn Sun) maintained a strong family line of Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) winners when taking out the \$3 million Classic in a top-class display at Caulfield on Saturday.

A dual winner from his two starts as a juvenile, including in Eagle Farm's Tattersall's Stakes (Listed, 1400m) in June, Autumn Boy returned as a three-year-old with a hugely promising runner-up effort behind Sixties (Flying Artie) in the Ming

Dynasty Quality (Gr 3, 1400m) on September 13.

Stepping up to elite-level company for the first time in the Golden Rose (Gr 1, 1400m) on September 27, the son of The Autumn Sun (Redoute's Choice) disappointed slightly with a seventh-placed run - beaten over eight lengths behind stablemate Beiwacht (Bivouac) at odds of \$4.50.

Despite that below-par effort, supporters of Autumn Boy seemed undeterred and backed the colt accordingly into a \$4.20 second-favourite on Saturday, support that would prove justified.

Ridden

by Damian Lane, Autumn Boy was mid-pack turning for home and angling for a clear run. However, once finding daylight he powered down the outside of his rivals and hit the front with 100 metres left to run, finding plenty to fend off the late challenge of Planet Red (Admire Mars) (\$31) by 0.8 lengths.

There was a further 1.7 lengths back to Observer (Ghaiyyath) (\$21) in third place.

Autumn Boy's victory not only emulated his sire's devastating success in the race for Waller in 2018, but also that of his grandsire Redoute's

Choice (Danehill), who narrowly defeated Testa Rossa (Perugino) to land the Guineas back in 1999.

"We're proud of all the horses that come through the stable," said Waller. "But when we've got champions like The Autumn Sun and we've got sons and daughters, it's pretty special.

"Last week, Autumn Glow, now it's a super colt with Autumn Boy.

"That looked his race. We like to just identify talent and then try and get them to that big ticket item.

"Today's such an important race in the horse's career, a colt who announces them on the big stage. Glenn Ritchie [owner] and his wife, they've been so supportive of us, Charlie [Duckworth, assistant trainer] and myself.

"They've become good friends of ours and kept investing, kept investing, and we've managed to buy them a really nice horse."

Asked about Autumn Boy's below-par effort in the Golden Rose last month, Waller said: "It was a track record time. Full credit to the winner [Beiwacht], he led them up and won. Our Team

The backmarkers just didn't quite get in the race because we were just running so quick.

"We didn't lose faith, the ratings people and our form guys said he's the one, and sure enough, they were right.

"The sectional timings suggested he actually ran quite well. It was his first time in the big dance or the big-time races. He's come through the run well; he's come down here with plenty of time.

Continued from page 2 "The team down here have done a great job. We brought him to Caulfield; we ticked all the boxes, everything suggested he was ready to run a big race."

As for future plans for this now stud-bound colt, Waller downplayed a potential crack at the Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m).

"Not sure. I don't normally because they're still babies," the trainer said of the Cox Plate.

"He's only had four or five starts, I think. So, it'll be unlikely for us, but we'll see what comes out next week, you've got the luxury of just sitting tight.

"He's not overly raced so you can do it, but we'll have to see how good Via Sistina's going."

Winning rider Lane was recording his second-successive victory in the Guineas, having landed the Group 1 aboard Private Life (Written Tycoon) last year.

"Beautiful colt just takes everything in his stride, very easy to deal with and a great turn of foot when needed." Lane said of the winner.

"So you need that to win these big races, and when he joined in, he really joined in.

"I had a great run. I was able to use my barrier speed and just found myself in a bit of a tricky spot in the corner. But once I navigated that, he put the race away pretty quick. Very easy horse to handle, and as a result, had a nice run."

In becoming Waller's second elite-level winner in the space of seven days following on from Autumn Glow's Epsom Handicap (Gr 1, 1600m) success last Saturday, Autumn Boy (3 c The Autumn Sun - Rosegarden by Savabeel) was also providing his Arrowfield Stud-based sire The Autumn Sun with a fifth individual Group 1 winner - and his second in the space of a week.


Bred by Richard Rutherford and purchased for \$200,000 by his trainer and Guy Mulcaster out of the Amarina Farm draft at the 2024 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale, Autumn Boy is one of two winners from three to race out of the unraced Savabeel (Zabeel) mare Rosegarden, herself from the extended family of Group 1 winner and Group 1 sire Shamexpress (O'Reilly).

Rosegarden has a juvenile colt by Yarraman Park's Hellbent (I Am Invincible) and, after not being covered the following season, produced a filly by Hellbent recently. The Autumn Sun is standing this season at a fee of \$66,000 (inc GST).

Boy's rise to being a Group 3 winner has been
achieved inside just 25 days, with a debut third
placing at Canterbury over 1250 metres on
September 17 followed by a maiden success at
Rosehill over 1400 metres on October 1.

Lining up in Saturday's \$500,000 event over 1800 metres, the colt son of Pierro (Lonhro) was sent off the \$4.50 joint-second favourite in the capacity 16-runner field and made light work of those 15 rivals under a confident Adam Hyeronimus ride.

Sent to the front after leaving the barriers, Shangri La Boy never saw another rival, kicking two lengths clear off the home bend and comfortably maintaining that advantage to the line to beat The Pearls (Proisir) (\$61) by 2.1 lengths. The third-placed San Giovanni (Zoustar) (\$21) finished a further 0.4 lengths behind.

"He's obviously got some great true staying capabilities there," co-trainer Adrian Bott said.

"Storm Boy [is] a great sprinter but this

horse in his own right [is] a very good stayer because he's up to this grade very quickly in his career.

"This is his first preparation, just his third start, so to get quickly up to the 1800 metres and do that in such dominant fashion, it's certainly encouraging."

A crack at the Spring Champion Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) at Randwick on October 25 is likely to be next in the offing for Shangri La Boy.

"Being by Pierro you always thought he might be more of a Classics style and physically that was the way he always presented right from the yearling stage," Bott said.

"I think we have to [go for the Spring Champion] after the manner in which he won that. It was a good test because it was 1400 metres up to 1800 metres on a relatively quick turnaround from the Wednesday meeting here ten days ago."

Although being marked down as one with huge potential over staying distances, Hyeronimus was also quick to credit Shangri La

> Boy's turn of foot inside the closing stages of Saturday's contest.

> "He finds that rhythm straight away. He's good from the gates but he's so relaxed after 100 metres and he was beautiful throughout the race," the winning rider said. "He's got a sharp turn of foot too."

Purchased for \$375,000 by his trainers and Kestrel Thoroughbreds out of Coolmore at the 2024 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale, Shangri La Boy is a half-brother to Group 2 scorer-turned-Coolmore stallion Storm Boy being the second foal out of Pelican (Fastnet Rock).

Pelican is a winning daughter of Fastnet Rock (Danehill) who is out of the NZ Horse of the Year and seven-time Group 1 scorer Seachange (Cape Cross). She has a two year-old filly by St Mark's Basilica (Siyouni), a yearling filly by Justify (Scat Daddy) and was covered last spring by the late Wootton Bassett (Iffraaj).

Shangri La Boy (3 c Pierro - Pelican by Fastnet Rock) was providing Coolmore's Pierro with his 40th individual stakes winner by winning on Saturday. Pierro is standing at Jerrys Plains Farm for a fee of \$33,000 (inc GST) this breeding season.

Blueblooded Hidden Motive set for Group 1 tasks after Roman Consul success

Capitalist (Written Tycoon) colt Hidden Motive put his name into the hat for future Group 1 races over the Spring Carnival when landing Saturday's Roman Consul Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) at Rosehill.

Trained by Newcastle-based Nathan Doyle, the three-year-old had only had two outings in stakes company prior to this weekend's Group 2, for a debut fourth in the Breeders' Plate (Gr 3, 1000m) in October 2024 and a last-start fifth in the Heritage Stakes (Listed, 1100m), but proved he was well up **Continued on page 5**

Ridden by Ashley Morgan, Hidden Motive took over the lead from Golden Slipper (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Marhoona (Snitzel) with 800 metres left to race and was never headed from that point, kicking clear with 300 metres to go before holding on by 0.3 lengths from the fastfinishing Beadman (Snitzel) (\$3.50) - who was denied clear running until late in the contest.

Marhoona (\$2), who had returned with a first-up win in the Heritage Stakes (Listed, 1100m), again ran well to be third - beaten 0.8 lengths by the winner.

Hidden Motive's win was a welcome one for both Doyle and Morgan, who only this week aborted The Everest (Gr 1, 1200m) plans for stable star and spelling paddock-bound Private Harry (Harry Angel).

"It has been a tough week, but you've just got to roll the punches and, like I said, it's a rollercoaster. You've just got to hold on and ride it out," Doyle said.

"Tomorrow's a new day, and that horse was very good today; it was a brilliant ride by Ash. He rated him well in front; he gave a good kick on the corner. There were a few unlucky runners in behind, but they pay on the post, and he's a Group 2 winner now.

"He's by Group 1 winner, out of Group 1 winner, so he's got the pedigree and hopefully, he can go on with that.

"He's got good tactical speed, which I think will help him go a long way. He's better off putting himself up to speed and taking bad luck out of the equation.

"He's a quality horse; he always looks a bit big in the mounting yard. I think he just takes a bit of racing to sort of come to hand and sort of prove that today third up.

"He has a great group of owners supporting us all the way, so we are very happy."

Peter Snowden, the trainer of unlucky runner-up Beadman, was reflective of the colt's run throughout under Tim Clark.

"No fault of Timmy's. Tactically he has ridden the right race behind the favourite but we didn't get the favours when we wanted," Snowden said.

"With only a hundred metres to go he was two-and-a-half lengths behind the winner and he has run it down to a head.

"It was good to see him hit the line hard and through the line he was excellent. He is on track."

Bred by Cressfield, Hidden Motive (3 c Capitalist - Secret Agenda by Not A Single Doubt) was purchased by his trainer and Kurrinda Bloodstock for \$120,000 at the 2024 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale and is the best of three winners from four foals to race out of the Robert Sangster Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m)-winning mare Secret Agenda (Not A Single Doubt).

Secret Agenda died in December last year, with her last foal being a yearling filly by Zoustar (Northern Meteor). Hidden Motive became the 27th individual stakes winner for Newgate Farm's Capitalist, who stands for a fee of \$44,000 (inc GST).

'I don't see why he couldn't be a weight-for-age horse in the future'

Queensland-based trainer Tony Gollan struck an elated character at Caulfield on Saturday after witnessing his determined fiveyear-old Transatlantic (Snitzel) go pillar-topost in the Toorak Handicap (Gr 1, 1600m).

Having run narrow seconds in the Sandown Stakes (Gr 3, 1500m) and Tontonan Stakes (Listed, 1400m) on his two starts prior, the gelded son of late Arrowfield great Snitzel (Redoute's Choice) arrived into the Group 1 handicap rated a \$10 chance.

Ridden expertly by Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m)-winning jockey Mark Zahra, Transatlantic ran the race at a tempo to suit and, having kept extra in reserve for the home straight, kept on willingly to deny the persistent challenge of Evaporate (Per Incanto) by 0.2 lengths.

The front pair finished a further 1.2 lengths clear of Leica Lucy (Derryn) back in third

"I've had one of those preparations where I've been beaten point one, point one," said Gollan. "But I was never really worried, I'd always planned to be here today. I think those defeats got him in here at the right weight.

"Mark [Zahra] executed his plan beautifully, he wanted to be aggressive that first hundred [metres], negate that barrier [in nine]. That's what he did, and that was the winning tactic.

"He had a plan; he had a fit horse, we got him in the right weight. Mark did the rest, you know? Horse and jockey, great combo, great to be back at Caulfield winning Group 1 races."

Transatlantic was a \$360,000 purchase for Gollan, Harbour Equine and John Foote Bloodstock from the 2024 Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale out of Segenhoe Thoroughbreds - who have remained in the ownership.

"We bought him as a yearling; we've had some ownership changes along the way. It's just terrific. We've had a bunch in and out of him, and it's just a great story, really. He's been a nice horse to get going, to win a Group 1 with him; it's just a great result," Gollan added.

"There's something in the water in Brisbane at the moment! Continued on page 6

Continued from page 5 "We gelded him at the end of his three-year-old year and that was the making of him.

"He's a really busy horse at home, I just thought a trip down here in a new environment, training him away from his home base.

"He's always had the potential and the ability to go to this level, and the trip away has made him, and he's a really quality horse. I don't see why he couldn't be a weight-for-age horse in the future."

Bred by Sir Owen Glenn's Go Bloodstock, Transatlantic is the third winner and first at stakes level from three to race out of the ATC Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m)-winning Darci Drama (Danehill) mare Gust Of Wind, who was the last horse to ever defeat champion mare Winx (Street Cry).

"The last mare that beat the mighty Winx, Gust Of Wind [is his dam]. So he's got a beautiful pedigree," Gollan said. "I've got no doubt he'll get further. But he was bloody good at a mile today."

Winning rider Zahra also was glowing in his report on the five-year-old: "Went out the gates, he was very quick out, which allowed him to get to the front and then [I] just had him where he wanted to be.

"He gave a good kick off the corner,

and he's used to seeing Evaporate's big head. This time, he was able to sort of be on the other side of the photo. It was a good win, well done to Tony.

"I knew I had a really nice time in front, and when I kicked, I knew I kicked good, and he thinks a bit, and I switched to the left, and I was hoping I wouldn't see anyone coming at me late.

"Then I knew it was Evaporate, I didn't have

> to look, and [he] showed good fight the last fifty [metres] to dig in and win."

> Gust Of Wind has a juvenile colt from the first crop of Newgate Farm's Stay Inside (Extreme Choice) who will be offered as Lot 26 at next week's Inglis Ready2Race Sale.

> Transatlantic (5 g Snitzel - Gust Of Wind by Darci Brahma) became the 25th individual Group 1 winner for the multiple champion sire Snitzel, who was euthanised earlier this year.

Two for Stay Inside

Newgate Farm's exciting first season sire Stay Inside (Extreme Choice) registered his second winner when Inhabit (2 f ex Jenga by All Too Hard) won on debut in Saturday's Moorundi Classic (900m) at Murray Bridge. Ridden by Todd Pannell for Michael Hickmott, the filly jumped well from the outside gate to take up the lead and kicked away from her rivals impressively, justifying her odds-on favouritism to win by 0.96 lengths over Blandford Baron (Extreme Warrior), with Rebel Tuesday (Rebel Dane) a further 2.23 lengths behind in third. Bred by Mr C Barham and Binalong Bloodstock, the filly was a \$200,000 buy for Michael Hickmott Bloodstock from Segenhoe Stud's draft at the 2025 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale. The second foal out of the winning All Too Hard (Casino Prince) mare Jenga, Inhabit is a half sister to the stakes-placed winner Kujenga (King's Legacy). Stay Inside stands at Newgate Farm in the Hunter Valley for an increased fee of \$66,000 (inc GST) this season.

ARROWFIELD STUD

Arrowfield Stud sire The Autumn Sun (Redoute's Choice) was supplied with his fifth individual Group 1 winner courtesy of Autumn Boy's (3 c ex Rosegarden by Savabeel) victory in Saturday's Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m). Bred by Mr R Rutherford, the colt was a \$200,000 purchase for his trainer Chris Waller and Mulcaster Bloodstock out of Amarina Farm's draft at the

2024 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale. He is the third foal out of the unraced Savabeel (Zabeel) mare Rosegarden, who herself is out of the Group 1-placed multiple stakes winner O'Reilly Rose (O'Reilly). After missing a season at stud last year, The Autumn Sun is standing at Arrowfield at an unchanged fee of \$66,000 (inc GST).

25 for Snitzel

Arrowfield Stud's late Champion Sire Snitzel (Redoute's Choice) added a 25th individual Group 1 winner to his glittering record when Transatlantic (5 g ex Gust of Wind by Darci Brahma) secured an all-the-way win in the Toorak Handicap (Gr 1, 1600m) at Caulfield on Saturday. Ridden to perfection by Mark Zahra for Tony Gollan, the gelding held off the fast finishing Evaporate (Per Incanto) to win by 0.15 lengths. Leica Lucy (Derryn) finished a further 1.25 lengths behind in third. Bred by Go Bloodstock, Transatlantic was purchased by his trainer, Harbour Equine and John Foote Bloodstock for \$360,000 out of Segenhoe's draft at the 2022 Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale. He is out of Gust Of Wind (Darci Brahma), who defeated legendary mare Winx (Street Cry) when landing the 2015 Australian Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m). She has produced five foals for three runners and three winners. Snitzel died aged 23 at Arrowfield Stud in June of this year.

Second for Charm Spirit

Haras du Grand Courgeon resident Charm Spirit (Invincible Spirit) sired his second elitelevel winner when Globe (7 g ex Bonnie Doon by Don Eduardo) scored a surprise victory in Saturday's Might And Power Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) at Caulfield. Passed in as a yearling, Globe sold to J Naito for \$22,000 out of Cambria Park's draft at the 2020 NZB National Yearling Sale. Bred by B Donoghue, the seven-year-old is one of three winners out of the unraced Don Eduardo (Zabeel) mare Bonnie Doon, herself a sister to dual Group 1 winner Booming.

Giga Kick bounces back in Schillaci

Giga Kick (Scissor Kick) returned to the winner's circle for the first time in more than two years when storming home to claim Saturday's \$300,000 Schillaci Stakes (Gr 2, 1100m) at Caulfield. Almost three years on from his historic triumph in The Everest (1200m), the gelding unleashed his trademark late burst under Craig Douglas to score a popular win by a length over Tropicus (Too Darn Hot), with Niance (Swiss Ace) another 0.8 lengths back in third. It marked Giga Kick's eighth career victory and first since the Doomben 10,000 (Gr 1, 1200m) in May 2023 - a drought that had seen critics question whether the son of Scissor Kick (Redoute's Choice) remained a genuine topliner. "It's a relief, to be honest...I'm going to get emotional," winning trainer Clayton Douglas said post-race. "It's good to have him back. He's been a lot of hard work. We've copped a lot of flak - they said he was fat and not ready first-up - but good horses do good things." The timing could hardly have been better with the \$20 million Group 1 Everest just a week away and one slot still open, and Douglas was quick to send a message to slotholders Yulong. "We'll have a chat anyway," he said. "You've got to remember, he had about \$4 million more than the rest of that field combined. For him to be a \$7 chance in that sort of race, and then blow them away, says it all. Give me a call, surely they know my number." Giga Kick, who ran a narrow second to Bella Nipotina (Pride Of Dubai) in last year's Everest, firmed to \$26 for this year's edition.

11 for Twilight Son

Twilight Son (Kyllachy) sired his 11th individual stakes winner when the Trent Busuttin and Natalie Young-trained Brayden Star (6 g ex Desert Liaison by Dansili) took out Saturday's Herbert Power Stakes (Gr 2, 2400m) at Caulfield. Ridden by Craig Williams, the gelding was extremely tough, fighting back after being headed in the straight to defeat Plymouth (The Autumn Sun) by 0.25 lengths, with Whiskey On The Hill (Ribchester) a further 0.15 lengths behind in third. Now raced

by Seymour Bloodstock, the six-year-old was bred in the northern hemisphere by Hungerford Park Stud and was sold at the 2019 Tattersalls December Foal Sale to Ebor Bloodstock for 17,000gns. He was subsequently sold to JCH Bloodstock for 25,000gns at the Book 2 of the 2020 Tattersalls October Yearling Sale when consigned by West Moor Stud, and was then purchased by Chris K Racing for 80,000gns when sold by The Bloodstock Connection at the 2021 Tattersalls Craven Breeze Up Sale. The sixth foal out of Desert Liaison (Dansili), Brayden Star is a half-brother to Group 3 scorer Wentwood (Pour Moi) and hails from the family of dual US Grade 1 winner Fiesta Gal (Alleged). Brayden Star secures Caulfield Cup slot

Luck finally fell the way of Brayden Star, who outlasted his rivals in a dramatic finish to Saturday's Herbert Power Stakes, earning his place in the Caulfield Cup (Gr 1, 2400m) in the process. Co-trainer Trent Busuttin confirmed Brayden Star will back up in next Saturday's \$5 million Group 1. "He's earned his chance," Busuttin told Racing. com. "He's a slow-maturing horse, but after a long spell following last spring, he's come back in career-best form." It was the gelding's third crack at the Herbert Power, having finished seventh and fourth in the previous two editions. Busuttin and training partner Natalie Young's best Caulfield Cup result remains Mirage Dancer's (Frankel) third in 2019. Plymouth's co-trainer Will Hayes said his team would consider a Caulfield Cup start, with the gelding sitting 24th in the order of entry. "It's a bit frustrating," Hayes said. "He hit the front too early and wobbled about, but it was still a terrific run." Haves confirmed stablemate Banker's Choice (Mongolian Khan) will line up in the Caulfield Cup after pleasing since a third placing in the RM Ansett Classic (Listed, 2415m) last time out.

31 for All Too Hard

Vinery Stud's All Too Hard (Casino Prince) sired his 31st individual stakes winner when Oh Too Good (6 m ex Good Oh by Duporth) took out Saturday's Ladies Day Vase (Gr 3, 1600m) at Caulfield. Ridden by Damian Lane for Kevin Daffy, the six-year-old mare bounced back

Globe steals the show in Might And Power upset

n a field of just four, Saturday's Might And Power Stakes was billed as a match between Treasurethe Moment (Alabama Express) and Buckaroo (Fastnet Rock), but it was Globe who upstaged his more fancied rivals with a commanding three-length victory.

The Mick Price and Michael Kent Jnrtrained gelding took control early, dictating a steady tempo before skipping clear in the straight. Treasurethe Moment chased gamely for second,

but could only get to within three lengths of the winner, with Buckaroo another 0.8 lengths away in third.

For Price, the decision to stay in Melbourne rather than contest the Hill Stakes (Gr 2, 1900m) in Sydney proved a masterstroke.

"It was a heist, wasn't it?" Price said.
"But you know, it's a horse race, not a
mathematical formula. We get up every day
and dream these dreams."

Price admitted the Might And Power hadn't been part of Globe's original campaign but said history had shown the race could throw up surprises.

"It was one of those races where you just have to roll the dice," he said. "He was beaten in a Ballarat Cup over 2000 metres as an immature horse, but he's much stronger now."

Winning rider Blake Shinn said Globe's natural on-pace style and the small field were key factors in the upset. "We went in as a bit of an underdog, but in these small tactical races, anything can happen. We had no pressure as the obvious leader – Globe's a natural front-runner, and it worked perfectly."

Treasurethe Moment's trainer Matt Laurie said he would assess the mare's recovery before confirming a Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) start.

"We'll see how she comes through this," Laurie said. "She prefers pressure up front and a solid tempo – she'll tell us in the next week or two whether we press on."

to the level she showed when finishing the 0.2-length runner-up to Lazzura (Snitzel) in the Let's Elope Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) at Flemington two starts back, always looking the winner of the Group 3, before duly stretching out to score by 1.25 lengths. Shalaa (Invincible Spirit) mare Jennilala was second, with Moonlight Circus

(Trapeze Artist) 0.15 lengths further back in third. Bred by Gilgai Farm, Oh Too Good is the first foal out of the winning Duporth (Red Ransom) mare Good Oh, herself a half-sister to six other winners out of Listed-winning Snitzel mare Zelsnitz. All Too Hard is standing for a reduced fee of \$27,500 (inc GST).

Daffy strikes gold with Oh Too Good in Vase

Pakenham-based trainer Kevin Daffy celebrated his first stakes success with his only horse when Oh Too Good proved too strong in Saturday's Ladies Day Vase. Starting a \$2.70 favourite, the four-year-old mare settled in the box seat under Damian Lane before challenging Jennilala in the straight, drawing clear to record a decisive victory. Oh Too Good has been a remarkable performer for Daffy, winning six of her 15 starts and earning more than \$775,000 in prize-money since debuting last year. "I'm so proud of her. So much goes into it, it's a really hard industry as we all know. I've come to it fairly late and dedicated my whole life to this horse," Daffy told Racing.com. "Every minute of every day is thought about this horse. If I'm not with her, I'm watching her and looking after her and making sure she's happy so she can come out and do her best and you saw the best today. I'm just over the moon, she's so deserving of this, I'm so proud of her. We saw what she can do and Damian Lane - what a champion." Lane was thrilled to deliver a fairytale result.

"Kev, his family, his friends that are in the horse, he does a great job with her," he said. "She's his only horse.He does such a good job to keep her going so well and winning a race on Caulfield Guineas Day."

Next month's Coolmore Stud Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) is firmly on the radar for emerging filly Point Barrow (Blue Point) after she produced an explosive finish to win at Caulfield on Saturday. Caught wide and third-last turning for home, the Sam and Anthony Freedmantrained daughter of Blue Point (Shamardal) looked no chance before surging late under Daniel Stackhouse to nail Surf's Up (Flying Artie) and Vein Girl (Blue Point) by 0.4 lengths. The victory, her third from five starts, saw Point Barrow's Coolmore Stud Stakes odds cut to \$10 (from \$21). "She's not a stakes winner yet, but she's stakes-placed, and we might've shown our hand today," Sam Freedman told Racing. com. "We'll look at either the Coolmore or The Roses on Oaks Day - she's got genuine straightline speed and a serious motor."

Newgate Farm resident Capitalist (Written Tycoon) notched up his 27th individual stakes winner when Hidden Motive (3 c ex Secret Agenda by Not A Single Doubt) took out Saturday's Roman Consul Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) at Rosehill. Bred by Cressfield, the colt was a \$120,000 purchase for his trainer Nathan Doyle and Kurrinda Bloodstock at the 2024 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale. Pierro stands at Coolmore Stud in the Hunter Valley for a reduced fee of \$33,000 (inc GST).

79 for Written Tycoon

Yulong Stud's stalwart sire Written Tycoon (Iglesia) scored his 79th individual stakes winner when Gangsta Granny (4 m ex Miss Hawaii by Manhattan Rain) gained a deserved black type victory in The Nivison (Gr 3, 1200m) at Rosehill on Saturday. Nash Rawiller hailed Lindermann's (Lonhro) never-say-die attitude after the six-year-old produced a commanding front-running performance to win Saturday's \$2 million Hill Stakes (Gr 2, 1900m) at Rosehill. The pair have built a strong rapport since reuniting earlier this year - Rawiller having guided the Chris Wallertrained gelding to victory in the 2023 Rosehill Guineas (Gr 1, 2000m) - and Saturday's triumph marked their fifth win together from their past ten starts. Following a Chelmsford Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m) win over Sir Delius (Frankel) and a brave second to Fangirl (Sebring) in the 7 Stakes (1600m), Lindermann controlled the Hill Stakes from the outset and never looked in danger, scoring by 2.2 lengths over Attrition (Churchill), with Queensland Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) winner Maison Louis (Super Seth) another length away in third. "His biggest asset isn't just his heart, it's his attitude," Rawiller said. "He never gives up. He probably knew he was more in front than I did, to be honest. He's just a horse that keeps coming through for you." Waller's assistant Darren Beadman said Lindermann could back up in next weekend's King Charles III Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m).

\$500,000 Tapp-Craig goes to Ohope

Ohope (I Am Invincible) landed a big payday on Saturday at Rosehill when the three-yearold I Am Invincible colt scored in the \$500,000 Tapp-Craig (1400m). Ridden by Tommy Berry for Michael Freedman, Ohope landed the 1400-metre contest by 1.7 lengths over Farnicle (Farnan) with a further 0.4 lengths back to Estremo (Extreme Choice) in third place. "He's a lovely colt, you know. I've been very privileged to get one, well a few from Godolphin, and this bloke was my first winner for them when he broke his maiden at Hawkesbury and I just love him," Freedman said. "I think he's a really progressive young horse, whether we press on further this prep or not, we'll wait and see. He loved that solid tempo today and I think he might have a mile in him so whether that's pressing on to Melbourne for a race down there, or giving him a break and looking at the Randwick Guineas or something like that, but he's a horse with a good future."

She's Bulletproof lands second stakes win

Charlotte Littlefield-trained She's Bulletproof (5 m Shooting To Win - Offshore Sham by Shamardal) added a second Group 3 victory to her CV when she held on to land the Northwood Plume Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) at Caulfield on Saturday. Ridden by Ben Allen, the five-year-old made the running and kicked clear off the home bend before late challenges by Gumdrops (Written Tycoon) and Vestas (Toronado) reduced her winning margin to 0.4 lengths. Successful in the Geoffrey Bellmaine Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) in February, She's Bulletproof took her record to five wins and seven placings from 15 starts, boosting her prize-money earnings to \$703,225.

42 for Deep Field

Walsh Bay (4 m ex Invading Humor by Invasor) became the 42nd individual stakes winner for Newgate Farm's pensioned stallion Deep Field (Northern Meteor) when scoring in Saturday's Queensland Cup (Listed, 2400m) at Eagle Farm. The Chris and Corey Munce-trained mare was ridden by Damien Thornton and denied So You Are (So You Think) by 0.2 lengths, with a further 2.2 lengths back to Tapildoodledo (Proisir) in third. Out of the stakes-winning Invasor (Candy Stripes) mare Invading Humor, Walsh Bay is a sister to winners Last Frontier and Finance Shogun. Deep Field was retired in 2022.

The Will Clarken-trained Cartoon Graveyard (6 g ex Star Hit by Euclase) provided his sire Turffontein (Johannesburg) with a tenth individual stakes winner when landing Saturday's Murray Bridge Gold Cup (Listed, 1600m). Ridden by Kayla Crowther, the sixyear-old gelding defeated Pudding (Tavistock) by 1.8 lengths, with a further 0.4 lengths back to Sir Kingsford (Sir Prancealot) in third. Out of the Listed-winning mare Star Hit (Euclase), Cartoon Graveyard is a half-brother to the Group 3-placed winner Zodiac Queen (King's Best).

Egan suspended for 18 meetings

Billy Egan has been handed an 18-meeting suspension following his ride in the Toorak Handicap at Caulfield. The dual Group 1 winner pleaded guilty to mid-range careless riding after crossing on Feroce (Super Seth) when insufficiently clear of Lazzura (Snitzel), who in turn tightened and badly hampered favourite Sepals (Calyx). Egan's suspension starts on October 19, before he is free to return on Melbourne Cup Day, November 4.

Rae runners impress with Ashburton double

Riccarton-based trainer Terri Rae sent an early message ahead of next month's New Zealand Cup Carnival, landing a classy double in \$50,000 open handicaps at Ashburton on Saturday. Rae struck first with Spot On Time (Time Test), who produced a stylish first-up win before stablemate Sir Albert (Savabeel) returned to his best 35 minutes later with a commanding two-length victory. A son of Savabeel (Zabeel), Sir Albert had won six of his first 14 starts but had gone winless in nine outings since March last year. He posted an emphatic trial win at Riccarton on September 29 and punters duly sent him out a \$2.10 favourite. Ridden patiently by Bruno Queiroz, Sir Albert tracked the speed from sixth along the rail before bursting between runners at the top of the straight. He quickened impressively to take control and was never threatened. "I was very confident with him today," the winning rider said. "The plan was to have him midfield and let him finish off. The last 200 metres he really flew home, he's a good horse and will improve again." Sir Albert is now rated a \$14 chance for the TAB Mile (Gr 3, 1600m) at Roccarton on November 12. Spot On Time meanwhile continued to build a strong record with his sixth victory from 11 starts. Ridden by Vinnie Colgan, he overcame an early three-wide run before grinding out a narrow but decisive win over Illicit Dreams (Vancouver). He is expected to be a key player again through the Cup Carnival meetings on November 8, 12 and 15.

Pike thrilled with stakesbound Churchillian

Tony Pike admitted satisfaction after he watched progressive mare Churchillian (Churchill) return to winning form at Taupo on Friday on what was her third run back from a substantial lay-off. It took a month for vets to determine she had suffered torn ligaments in a hock and needed a lengthy spell to recover. Two trials in August preceded a useful first-up run for seventh at Ellerslie in September, however a tough run where she had to sit three and four-wide at the same venue a fortnight later undid a lot of that early progress. The six-yearold led from the jump in Friday's 1300-metre contest under Sam Collett to destroy a handy field by two lengths. "That was very satisfying as she had been off the scene a long time and looked back to somewhere near her best on Friday," Pike said. "Sam had her away nicely and when she shot clear on the turn I thought she would be hard to pull back if her fitness held up and thankfully she was still going pretty strongly at the line." Pike will now have a chat with connections regarding plans for an assault on the Riccarton carnival, where she holds a nomination for the TAB Mile. "I'm keen to have a crack at the Canterbury Breeders' Sakes on the first day at Riccarton [November 8] and if she went well we might back up in the TAB mile," he said.

Marsh hoping Rotorua dries ahead of team assault

Stephen Marsh has been keeping a close eye on the weather forecast as he prepares a ten-strong team from his Cambridge base for Sunday's Rotorua meeting. With the track rated a Heavy 9 on Saturday, Marsh was hoping drying conditions will improve it. "We'd been hoping for some fine weather over the last couple of days as most of ours need a better surface,"

the trainer said. "A couple have poor draws so they might wait for another day, but if the track improves, the rest will take their chance." Among his key contenders are To Cap It All (Capitalist) and Lubeck (Hanseatic), who line up in the three-year-old 1215-metre contest as they build towards summer targets. "To Cap It All is a 1,000 Guineas candidate and we think she's back on track for Riccarton next month," Marsh said. "She was a bit disappointing at Ellerslie but her bloods weren't right afterwards, which explained it. She needs a Dead 4 to be at her best, but she's in an early race when the track will be at its best, so she can go a cheeky gallop. Lubeck did nothing wrong at two, a win and a second from two runs, and she's been working well. She'll take improvement, but I'm expecting a good effort." Glamour Tycoon (Written Tycoon) will tackle the Sweynesse Stakes (Gr 3, 1215m). "She's so genuine and tries her heart out every time," Marsh continued. "It's a strong field, but she's come on nicely from her first-up run and should put herself in the race."

Otaki meeting rescheduled to Thursday

The Otaki-Maori meeting, originally set to take place on Saturday, has been rescheduled to October 16. New Zealand Thoroughbred Racing said the decision was made "after considering weather forecasts, upcoming race programmes, and servicing requirements." The meeting will run as a new raceday, retaining the same programme as originally planned. Preference will be given to horses that had accepted for Saturday's abandoned meeting, excluding the Spring Sprint (Gr 3, 1200m), "given pattern ground rules."

Gewan (2 c ex Grey Mystere by Lethal Force) became the ninth individual Group 1 winner for Darley stallion Night Of Thunder (Dubawi) and first UK Group 1 winner for his owners Yulong when causing an upset in Saturday's Dewhurst Stakes (Gr 1, 7f) at Newmarket. Having won his opening two starts, including the Acomb Stakes (Gr 3, 7f), the colt disappointed when favourite for the Champagne Stakes (Gr 2, 7f) at Doncaster on his most recent outing but bounced back this weekend as he ran on well inside the final furlong to deny Coventry Stakes (Gr 2, 6f) scorer Gstaad (Starspangledbanner) by three-quarters of a length. There was a further length and a half back to Distant Storm (Night Of Thunder) in third place. Bred by Overbury Stallions and Dukes Stud, Gewan was purchased by Longways Stables for 100,000gns out of Book 2 at the Tattersalls October Yearling Sale and was re-sold to JS Bloodstock and Al Rabban Racing for 80,000 at this year's Argana May Breeze-Up Sale, before then being purchased privately by Yulong last month. He is the second foal out of the Listed-placed Lethal Force (Dark Angel) mare Grey Mystere. Night Of Thunder stood the 2025 northern hemisphere breeding season at Kildangan Stud for a fee of €150,000 (approx. AU\$269,120).

67 for Camelot

Coolmore's former shuttler Camelot (Montjeu) sired his 67th individual stakes winner when the Aidan O'Brien-trained Pierre Bonnard (2 c ex Sultanina by New Approach) landed the Zetland Stakes (Gr 3, 1m 2f) at Newmarket on Saturday. Ridden by Christophe Soumillon, the juvenile colt led narrowly with a furlong left to race and readily pulled a length and a half clear of stablemate Endorsement (Wootton Bassett). There was a length further back to Del Maro (Camelot) in third place. Bred by Rathasker Stud, Pierre Bonnard was first purchased by Camas Park Stud for €80,000 at the 2023 Goffs November Foal Sale before

being re-sold to MV Magnier for €280,000 at the following year's Goffs Orby Yearling Sale and is raced by a partnership which includes John Magnier, Michael Tabor, Derrick Smith and Westerberg. Trained by Karl Burke and ridden by Clifford Lee, the juvenile colt made all and kept on well inside the closing stages to deny Al Zanati (Dubawi) by a length and a quarter, with a further head back to Glacius (Too Darn Hot) in third place. Bred by George Kent, Hankelow was first purchased for 210,000gns by Atlas Bloodstock at the 2023 Tattersalls December Foal Sale before being re-purchased by his trainer for 750,000gns out of Book 1 at the 2024 Tattersalls October Yearling Sale. He races in the silks of Sheikh Mohammed Obaid Al Maktoum. A half-brother to Listed winner Epic Poet (Lope De Vega) and the Listed-placed winner La Filomena (Lope De Vega), he is the third foal out of the Listed-placed Lawman (Invincible Spirit) mare Sagaciously, herself a half-sister to the dam of Group 1 winner Perfect Power (Ardad).

UK: Back-to-back stakes wins for Damysus

Desvio (4 g Yoshida - Fitzrovia by Uncle Mo) got the better of his more fancied rivals when running out a surprise winner of the Sycamore Stakes (Gr 2, 12f) at Keeneland on Friday. The Madison Meyers-trained gelding defied his odds of 34-1 to notch a second stakes success, and third victory overall, when he beat Safe Trip Home (More Than Ready) by a half-length. Utah Beach (English Channel) finished two lengths behind the winner in third. Desvio is out of the unraced Uncle Mo (Indian Charlie) mare Fitzrovia, who herself is a daughter of Grade 1 winner Marylebone (Unbridled's Song). Fitzrovia boasts four winners from as many starters.
