Tulloch Lodge hoping Shangri La Boy can shine in Spring Champion

Gai Waterhouse is confident she can repeat a sibling trick 23 years on when she and Adrian Bott send favourite Shangri La Boy (Pierro) into Saturday's Spring Champion Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) at Randwick.

In 2002, Waterhouse won the three-year-old feature with the younger sibling of a shorter-course star, when Redoute's Choice's (Danehill)

little brother Platinum Scissors outstayed his rivals for Jim Cassidy.

This week she'll be striving to win the race with Shangri La Boy, the year-younger half-brother to Tulloch Lodge's former gun two-year-old speedster Storm Boy (Justify).

While Storm Boy's five victories from ten starts ranged from 1100 metres to 1200 metres - en route to his current first spring standing at Coolmore Stud for \$16,500 (inc GST) - Shangri La Boy has quickly shown he'll likely be suited by longer trips.

Purchased by Waterhouse and Bott and Bruce Slade's Kestrel Thoroughbreds for \$375,000 at Magic Millions Gold Coast - where a year earlier they'd paid \$460,000 for Storm Boy - Shangri La Boy only debuted on September 17.

That 1.09-length third over 1250 metres at Canterbury was followed by a 2.18 length midweek maiden win over 1400 metres at Rosehill. Stepped up two furlongs for the Gloaming Stakes (Gr 3, 1800m), the colt showed he relished the further distance by leading throughout for a 2.11-length triumph.

Bookmakers have Shangri La Boy favourite for the Spring Champion at around \$3.40, ahead of Godolphin's Joe Pride-trained \$3.80 shot Attica (Lonhro), another who's well bred as the first foal of Darley's seven-time stakes winner Savatiano (Street Cry).

Waterhouse also trained Shangri La Boy's Coolmore sire Pierro (Lonhro), the five-time Group 1 winner and two-year-old Triple Crown hero. She sees a lot of the sire in the son,

just as she sees shared characteristics between the two "boys" of broodmare Pelican (Fastnet Rock) - Shangri La and Storm Boy - that mare's only two named foals so far.

"I can't see any reason why Shangri La Boy can't win this Saturday," Waterhouse, chasing her fifth win in the race, told ANZ News.

"He's got great speed, and he's got that lovely strength about himself. He's by Pierro - a champion racehorse and a champion sire - and I love the way this horse pins his ears back when other horses come to him.

"That's exactly the way Pierro used to race - exactly. He used to pin the ears back and say, 'Get out of my way.'

"Shangri La Boy does exactly the same thing. It's amazing. And Storm Boy used to do the same thing too. Not every horse does it, but those three horses really have had that attribute.

"So I think with Shangri La Boy and Storm Boy, obviously their mother had a bit to do with it as well. She's been a damn good broodmare so far."

Pelican won twice at 1000 metres and 1200 metres, including in a Melbourne metro two-year-old handicap, but appears to have inherited some stamina not only from her sire Fastnet Rock but her outstanding dam.

Seachange (Cape Cross) was New Zealand's Horse of the Year in 2007 and 2008, and while she was also its Champion Sprinter in that second year, three of her seven elite victories came over 1600 metres, and she was Group 1-placed over 2040 metres.

For Pierro's part, four of his 40 stakes winners have scored at further than 2400 metres, while he's sired five Derby winners - and 2019 Spring Champion victor Shadow Hero.

Waterhouse said she'd been surprised to acquire Shangri La Boy for \$85,000 less than his fellow Coolmore-bred sibling Storm Boy, considering the latter had won his first two starts by then.

"Storm Boy as a yearling was a lovely big strong horse, and good boned," Waterhouse said.

"And Shangri La Boy was the half-brother, by a proven sire in Australia in Pierro, so I said we should buy him.

"I was very surprised he didn't bring more money. But there's such a lot of know-alls in the sales ring, and thank the lord there are.

"It's nice buying or being given horses where you know the dam or the granddam. You can see the similarities if there are some. They're not always there, but most times they are."

And while he was something of a late bloomer, Waterhouse feels Shangri La Boy - part of the "Shangri La" team of Shanghai textiles millionaire Tony Huang - has come into a golden period at the right time.

"Horses, when they come right, can just go ahead in leaps and bounds. It's so exciting," she said. "You only have to see the Caulfield Cup winner [Half Yours]. He's done the same sort of thing.

"I'm pretty confident about Saturday. Shangri La Boy is a very talented horse, he should get the run of the race from gate two, he's got a good jockey in Nash Rawiller, and I can't see any reason why he can't lead all the way over the 2000 metres."

Waterhouse has fond memories of Platinum Scissors, one of three Group 1 winners among five stakes victors for the remarkable broodmare Shantha's Choice (Canny Lad), and another horse who came from nowhere in a hurry. Yet she still angsts over what might have been.

"I was really concerned with him before he raced. He couldn't go at all - couldn't scratch himself. So I said to his owner Muzaffar Yaseen, who'd also had Redoute's Choice, 'Should we geld him?' He said no," Waterhouse said.

"Then at his second trial he came home really well under Darren Beadman, and I rang Mr Yaseen and said, 'Redoute's brother has revealed himself!'

"In his first prep he won the Spring Champion, then the Norman Robinson next start, and was favourite for the VRC Derby. But he got terribly sick and was never the same horse. He won a Group 2 and a Group 3, but he was never able to achieve the heights we'd thought he would.

"But Shantha's Choice - what a fabulous broodmare. Pelican might be on the same track. It's a pretty big ask - Shantha's Choice is one of the great broodmares - but you never know.

"We won the Spring Champion with a brother to Redoute's. Hopefully we can do something similar with the half-brother to Storm Boy, and there'll be a bit of symmetry there."

Waterhouse in fact did achieve something similar with her second Spring Champion winner, Magic Of Sydney in 1996, who came a year after her first one with another son of Danehill in the exceptional Nothin' Leica Dane.

Magic Of Sydney's year-younger full-brother Daney Boy had won Perth's two-year-old feature sprint, the Karrakatta Plate (Gr 1, 1200m) back when it still had top-tier status.

Waterhouse said Shangri La Boy was unlikely to follow Platinum Scissors' path towards the VRC Derby (Gr 1, 2500m), but her stable's second Spring Champion runner Champagne Hero (Maruice) - another colt carrying Huang's colours - probably would.

A \$600,000 Gold Coast purchase for Waterhouse and Bott and Kestrel, from the draft of breeders Rosemont Stud, Champagne Hero has won two of five at Wyong and Newcastle, before a fair 4.54-length seventh in the Gloaming, and is at \$16 for the Spring Champion.

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Onesmoothoperator books his Melbourne Cup ticket

The Brian Ellison-trained Onesmoothoperator (Dialed In) punched his ticket for the Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) at Flemington a week on Tuesday with an ultra impressive win under the lights in Friday's Moonee Valley Gold Cup (Gr 2, 2500m).

The seven-year-old was ruled out of the defence of his Geelong Cup (Gr 3, 2400m) on Wednesday after wet and windy weather meant the race was postponed until Thursday. However, the change of plan persuaded his connections to head to Moonee Valley instead.

Despite going winless since his dominant victory at Geelong last year, including running 12th as a \$7 chance in last year's Melbourne Cup, Onesmoothoperator was sent out the \$4.20 favourite under Mark Zahra. After travelling towards the back, the gelding sliced through the field impressively to win by three-quarters of a length.

Ellison said the genuine tempo up front suited Onesmoothoperator's racing style and said it was all systems go to Flemington.

"I thought we had a bit to do at one stage, but when he pulled him out, he picked up well," Ellison said.

"I know he's got a great turn of foot, you just

can't ride him handy, you have to ride him for luck. He gave him a great ride."

"We needed a gallop on, and there was plenty of gallop on. I thought 'are we in trouble here' but when he got him rolling... he'll improve for the run as well."

Onesmoothoperator is yet to have his final scans done for the Melbourne Cup, which ruled out race-favourite Sir Delius in recent days, but Ellison said the horse is ready to go.

"I just want ten days with no dramas like we did last year, like we've had before, and he'll run well at Flemington," Ellison said.

"I'm not sure he's going to win it because it's a really hot race, but he won't disgrace himself.

"He goes for his bone scan tomorrow again, and hopefully, he comes out of that alright. He got vetted this morning, he got vetted two days ago, everything's good."

Onesmoothoperator was allotted 52 kilograms for the Flemington showpiece on November 4, but is eligible for a penalty after Friday's triumph.

With Zahra committed to ride topweight Al Riffa, Ellison confirmed last year's Caulfield Cup winning jockey Harry Coffey had been booked to ride Onesmoothoperator, who has cut into \$11 for the Melbourne Cup.

Laurie warns against writing off Treasurethe Moment

his mare is ready to deliver despite two recent defeats. The Feehan Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) and Might And Power Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) results were below expectations for the short-priced favourite, but Laurie insists they were more a product of race shape than any fault of the horse. "She's most certainly improved from these last two runs," Laurie said. "There's no question that they weren't run to suit - they were obviously a bit unusual with such small fields. When you're a short-priced favourite and you don't win, it's disappointing. But if I was to line up [Pride Of] Jenni and Globe in a track gallop, I'd expect they would beat Treasure - and that's basically what we saw. We just need a race where there's pace on, pressure on, and horses coming back.

Hopefully she can absorb it and come into her own." With Globe scratched on Thursday, there's uncertainty about how much early tempo the Cox Plate will feature, though Ciaran Maher has flagged plans for Light Infantry Man (Fast Company) to go forward. "That faster pace seems to be what best suits her - it's a Cox Plate, they don't run them slow," Laurie said. "She'll get her chance. She's on the rail, she's got the shortest way home, and it'll be interesting because they'll all be making runs out wide. I just think it's a bit rich to be writing her off following those two races." Treasurethe Moment will jump from barrier one with Damian Lane aboard and is currently rated a \$6 chance in early Cox Plate markets.



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Nepotism ready for Cox Plate challenge

It's been 13 years since the Hawkes Racing team last saddled a three-year-old in the Cox Plate, and this Saturday Nepotism (Brutal) will attempt to emulate his close relation All Too Hard (Casino Prince) and perhaps go one better. The Champagne Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) winner is the only three-year-old in this year's edition and although unplaced in three spring runs, co-trainer Michael Hawkes believes the colt's class and upside justify taking on Australia's best. "Cox Plates aren't just there to be run in, you're running to win," Hawkes told Racing.com. "You've got to have a good three-year-old that's looking for ground and will be competitive. Everyone saw his Champagne win; he's older, stronger and ready for 2000 metres now." Hawkes said the colt, out of a sister to four-time Group 1 winner turned Group 1 sire All Too Hard, who was himself second in the Cox Plate at three, has matured physically and mentally since his juvenile season. He added that his 49.5-kilogram lightweight is a genuine advantage. "He's up against a quality field but he's a quality colt himself and deserves his place," Hawkes said. "At 49.5 kilos, he gets a big pull in the weights, and that's significant at this level. His work on Tuesday was great...and he's got the ability - that's why he's there. It's a big ask, but he's earned his chance." Zac Lloyd, fresh off a treble at last weekend's Everest meeting, takes the ride.

Freedman's Cox Plate dream alive with Attrition

Mitchell Freedman will saddle Attrition (Churchill) in Saturday's Cox Plate at Moonee Valley, aiming for an upset in the eight-horse field. The six-year-old entire may not have the credentials of some rivals, and has not won in over 12 months, but Freedman believes he deserves his shot at the big-time. Attrition comes off a second in the Hill Stakes (Gr 2, 1900m) at Rosehill on October 11, a race he won last year, following a closing third to Pride Of Jenni (Pride Of Dubai) in the Feehan Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m) at The Valley on September 26. "We always had it pencilled in that we would try and go to the race this year," Freedman said. "It's been a dream to have a runner in the race, and we've shared that dream with the owners. He ran really well the last time, and he's been in and around the mark

at weight-for-age for a long time now and he deserves a crack at it." Freedman praised Kerrin McEvoy's bold ride in the Hill Stakes, where Attrition was settled further back than intended before making ground outside the eventual winner, Lindermann (Lonhro). "That was pretty bold by Kerrin McEvoy," Freedman said. "I don't reckon there would have been too many riders do what he did. It was a bold move, it worked out well and he really stuck on and his work near the line was really super. I've been really happy with him since and we're really looking forward to the Cox Plate." Craig Williams has the ride on Saturday from barrier two.

Portelli pair looking to upset the odds

Gary Portelli has made a habit of producing surprise packets during the spring, and he's hopeful Queen Of Clubs (Maurice) and Encap (Capitalist) can follow that trend at Randwick on Saturday. Much like stable star Kimochi (Brave Smash) last year, the Warwick Farm horseman believes his pair can make their presence felt at double-figure odds in two feature races on the card. Queen Of Clubs (\$20) takes her place in the Spring Champion Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m), stepping up in trip after a luckless run in the Flight Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) earlier this month, where she was found to have suffered cardiac arrhythmia when finishing eighth. "She has come through the run well," Portelli said. "She's had a couple of big bits of work since the race. They can have a heart arrhythmia once and it never happens again. We were devastated during the Flight Stakes to see her basically fail to run on - that's usually her go. She usually accelerates. They usually bounce back." Meanwhile, Encap will line up in the Five Diamonds Prelude (1500m) as he looks to snap a year-long winless streak. The gelding turned in an eye-catching performance in the Epsom Handicap (Gr 1, 1600m) earlier this month, finishing just 4.2 lengths behind Golden Eagle (1500m) favourite Autumn Glow (The Autumn Sun). "Encap is coming out of the Epsom and it was a good run," Portelli said. "He ran the second-fastest last 600 [metres] of the race again from last. Hopefully things are run to suit." Encap is rated a \$15 chance for the Prelude, where he'll face Toorak Handicap (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Transatlantic (Snitzel).

Miss Roumbini ready to make amends in The Invitation

Mick Price believes talented mare Miss Roumbini (Zoustar) can finally be rewarded for her consistency when she lines up in Saturday's \$2 million The Invitation (1400m) at Randwick. The five-year-old was set to make her Sydney debut earlier this month in the Alan Brown Stakes (1400m), for which she was favourite, but was withdrawn in the days prior. "She got a travel bug on the way to Sydney, but her blood picture is good now and her gallop Saturday morning was super dupe," Price said. "She's nice and bright. I was there during the week and she looks fantastic and I think she'll be hard to beat." Trained in partnership with Michael Kent Jnr, Miss Roumbini will jump from barrier seven, potentially six if the emergency doesn't gain a start, with Adam Hyeronimus booked to ride. While it will be her first official Sydney appearance, the mare has right-handed experience, having claimed the \$1 million Magic Millions Fillies & Mares (1300m) at the Gold Coast in January. This campaign, she has finished runner-up in both starts at Caulfield, chasing home Magic Time in the Cockram Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) before a strong second behind Sepals (Calyx) in the Sir Rupert Clarke Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m). "The time between runs I don't think will worry her," Price said. "She's that type of filly, she's got to be looking for something to do. I think that's fine and 1400 will be good for her. I'm looking forward to it."

Gibbons confident Young Mister Grace can measure up

Dylan Gibbons believes unbeaten colt Young Mister Grace (Anders) deserves his shot at stakes company, taking confidence from trainer Brad Widdup's decision to bypass an easier option for Saturday's Brian Crowley

Stakes (Listed, 1200m) at Randwick. The three-year-old has made a faultless start to his career, winning both outings comfortably on his home track at Hawkesbury over the past month, and Gibbons says he's ready for the next step. "I was also booked for him in the Midway and they didn't accept, so I'd say from everything Brad's seen, he's happy and didn't give himself the option," Gibbons told Racing NSW. "He moves like a nice horse. It's obviously a big step up but I think he can handle it. He was very well placed for his first start, Brad found a nice easy race and he was able to be a dominant winner. Drawn one the other day, I wanted to lead up on him and make a good thing of him, but he got a bit lost in front and still did it well. Both wins have had good merit and he's learned two different things." Young Mister Grace was rated the \$4.80 second favourite on Friday behind Miss Freeloze (Tassort), and Gibbons believes the market has the pair positioned fairly. "I rode Whatalegacy when Miss Freeloze won at Warwick Farm, and I've got this horse just a touch ahead of him," he said. "I don't think Whatalegacy was at his best, and once this bloke gets up in grade, he'll only get better." Gibbons will also partner More Territories (Territories) in The Invitation and says the mare can be competitive if the race is run to suit. "I'm hoping for some speed. She went enormous last start with good tempo over 1200 metres," he said. "She'll be out the back, but she's flying and will be running home in some slick sectionals."

Maher plays long game with Derby-bound Observer

Ciaran Maher has opted for patience over prestige, confirming that exciting colt Observer (Ghaiyyath) will bypass the Cox Plate at The Valley in favour of the Drummond Golf Vase (Gr 2, 2040m) on Saturday. The Godolphin-owned three-year-old was the hard-luck story of the Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) earlier this month, flashing home for third behind Autumn Boy (The Autumn Sun) after striking trouble in the straight. While a Cox Plate berth was on the table, Maher and Godolphin agreed that a steadier progression towards the Victoria Derby (Gr 1, 2500m) at Flemington next week was the correct move. "He's bounced through his Guineas run and I was sort of toying with the

Cox Plate," Maher said. "But speaking with the Godolphin team, we decided to go to the Vase and then on to the Derby. He's very lightly raced: that Guineas run was just his fifth start. If you look back at the horses that have won the Cox Plate, apart from So You Think, most had more racing under their belts. He's not fully rounded yet in terms of his racing patterns. You see a horse like Tempted take on the older horses, she's very well-rounded. Observer is still reasonably raw, and that was the catalyst. He's a raw horse with a very bright future and could run in the next four Cox Plates." Maher has no concerns about the rise in trip: "I expected him to run well in the Guineas, he's by Ghaiyyath, and they seem to be really hitting their straps here now," he said. "Saturday's distance will suit perfectly, and the Derby trip won't bother him either."

Coolmore contenders jump out at Flemington

Several leading Coolmore Stud Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) contenders stepped out at Flemington on Friday, with Beadman (Snitzel) producing the standout effort in a straight-course jump-out alongside Beiwacht (Bivouac) and Skyhook (Written Tycoon). The trio were joined by Gallo Nero (Wootton Bassett), Bosustow (Blue Point) and Balastier (Brazen Beau), the latter showing early pace to win the heat. Beadman's strong work through the line suggested he has taken improvement from his second placing behind Hidden Motive (Capitalist) in the Roman Consul Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m), a proven Coolmore lead-up that has produced the past two winners, Switzerland (Snitzel) and Ozzmosis (Zoustar). Beiwacht and Skyhook were not asked to do much but gained valuable experience down the straight, a factor often important for Sydney-based runners heading to the Flemington feature. In the following

heat, Hidden Motive and Point Barrow (Blue Point) also had a look at the straight, with Hidden Motive proving too strong. Fillies Vein Girl (Blue Point) and Cantiamo (Too Darn Hot) also impressed, the latter continuing her rise through the grades after two confident wins earlier in the campaign.

Widden Stud juveniles shine at Rosehill trials

Two juveniles bred by Widden Stud impressed at Rosehill trials on Friday morning, each winning their respective heats. The standout was The Next Episode (Snitzel), a \$2.8 million Magic Millions sale topper trained by Ciaran Maher and ridden by Jason Collett. The colt followed the leader before powering past to win the 900-metre trial by over two lengths. He is second foal of Group 3 winner Humma Humma (Denman), making him a half-brother to Group 3-placed Price Tag (Zoustar). The second heat was taken out by Spicy Miss (Trapeze Artist), also prepared by Maher and ridden by Collett for Darby Racing. Purchased for \$150,000, the filly worked through along the fence to score a narrow win. She is the second named foal of Sweet Gisel, a Street Boss mare from a US black-type family.

Cogburn to return to Kentucky after below-par fertility results

Grade 1-winning sprinter Cogburn (Not This Time) will return to WinStar Farm in Kentucky earlier than planned after disappointing fertility results during his first southern hemisphere-covering season at Widden Stud. The shuttle stallion covered 194 mares in his first year in America, with 143 confirmed in foal. But his fertility results in Australia have been far lower than this. "We are all terribly disappointed not to have been able to fulfill the obligations to the breeders who had supported Cogburn with a full book, but it's important we do what is in the best interests of Cogburn and the syndicate and resolve this temporary issue," said Antony Thompson of Widden Stud. WinStar's Elliott Walden said the decision was made so the horse could undergo further testing ahead of his 2026 season. "We want to get Cogburn home to do more testing to prepare him for his second

season at stud," Walden said. "I want to thank Antony and his team for the care of Cogburn during his time in Australia. The test results of his semen have been very good, but we need to dig a little deeper to understand what is going on. He is an important horse for our future, and we want to get him ready for 2026."

Multiple Group 1 winner Provence (Savabeel) tuned up for her summer campaign with a decisive 1100-metre trial win at Ellerslie on Thursday. The Stephen Marsh-trained mare tracked the leader before taking control in the

NZB Breeze Up footage now available online

The countdown to New Zealand Bloodstock's 2025 Ready to Run Sale is officially underway, with the highly anticipated breeze up videos now available to view online at **nzb.co.nz**.

Over two days at Te Rapa Racecourse on Monday and Tuesday, more than 380 juveniles galloped down the home straight, with the final 200 metres of each gallop individually timed to provide buyers with valuable insight into their speed and stride.

Day 1 saw 184 two-year-olds breeze in fine conditions following an early shower, recording an average time of 10.88 seconds on a Soft 6 track, with wind gusts increasing to 21.2 km/h in the evening. On Day 2, a further 202 youngsters took to the track under breezy conditions, with gusts up to 26.7 km/h and the surface rated a Soft 5, producing an average time of 10.93 seconds.

Across both sessions, the combined average was 10.91 seconds, reflecting a consistent level of quality across the catalogue.

Each breeze up video, filmed in high definition from approximately the 500-metre mark, captures the horses as they lengthen into their gallops. The videos are accompanied by full timing and weather data, including wind readings and direction, and can be downloaded directly from the website.

The footage will also be broadcast lot-by-lot on Trackside NZ (schedule to be confirmed), and on Racing.com in Australia on Monday, October 27, from 6am to 9.30am (AEDT).

In the lead-up to the sale, on-farm parades will commence from Monday, November 4, with the full schedule to be released soon.

She's going to improve again out of the 1100, she's ready to go to the races." Provence is set to resume at Te Rapa on November 8 in an open 1200-metre event, before progressing

to the Auckland Thoroughbred Breeders' Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) at Pukekohe. "She'll head to Te Rapa on the 8th of November, she'll run in the Open 1200 metres there and get a little bit of weight," Marsh said. "That'll springboard her to the mare's 1400 at Pukekohe, which will be ideal second-up. I think she's sharp enough to run a good race at 1400, but the mile is probably her sweet spot at the moment."

She's A Dealer ready to step up after eye-catching trial

Talented mare She's A Dealer (Ace High) looks set to fulfil her black-type potential in the upcoming campaign. Trained by Roger James and Robert Wellwood, the four-year-old made an impressive return from a break at Ellerslie trials on Thursday. Settling well back before moving across the top, she swept home down the outside to win her 1100m heat under regular rider George Rooke. "She trialled very well and as long as she comes through it nicely, she'll be stepping out at the races in three weeks or so," Wellwood said. "She looks to have an exciting summer ahead of her." She's A Dealer had a delayed start to her three-year-old season last term due to a lung infection. After an unplaced debut, she won consecutive races at Ellerslie and Te Rapa before heading to Australia. She finished runner-up over 1800 metres on a heavy Randwick track and was a gallant fifth in the Queensland Oaks (Gr 1, 2200m) on soft ground. "We've always had a lot of time for her and illness stopped her campaign last spring and when she came back, she really did it all off one preparation," Wellwood said. "She didn't get tracks to suit her in Australia but ran very well and she has really strengthened up and matured a lot. She can still run and win a Rating 75 and then we'll be looking at the mares' races with her."

Breslin weighing up Riccarton Classics for Intention

Mike Breslin is weighing up the next step for his filly Intention (Bivouac) after her run in Sunday's Upper Hutt Car Sales LTD Three-Year-Old 1400 at Trentham. The daughter of Bivouac (Exceed And Excel) is being aimed at Riccarton next month, with the trainer considering either the New Zealand 1,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) on November 8 or the New Zealand 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) a week later. "We haven't decided which one she will run in yet. She will only run in one of them and we will make that call after she races on Sunday," Breslin said. The Awapuni trainer was encouraged by her last-start third in the Canterbury Belle Stakes (Listed, 1200m) at Christchurch. "That was a bit of a test run," he said. "She coped exceedingly well and we have given her plenty of time to get over that trip

because we always had in the back of our mind that she might need to go back down there again in November. She had a reasonably easy time when she got back from the Canterbury Belle and this is the race we picked out for her to bring her up to 100 percent for Christchurch. The set weights and penalties don't suit her for that race on Sunday. She is not very good in at the weights for a smallish three-year-old filly, but the race will serve its purpose in getting her 100 per cent fit." Intention had a hit-out at the Foxton trials on Tuesday, finishing third in her 850-metre heat. Breslin said the trial had been beneficial. "I am really happy with her, I just gave her a quiet trial," he said. "She did everything under her own steam and I was more than happy with her."

Forsman duo target Sarten Memorial

Andrew Forsman will have a busy weekend with runners at Ellerslie, Te Rapa, The Valley and Sale, highlighted by a two-pronged tilt at the James and Annie Sarten Memorial (Gr 2, 1400m) at Te Rapa on Monday. His Sarten contenders, Quondo (Wootton Bassett) and Virgo Viva (Ribchester), are being aimed at key lead-ups to the 1000 Guineas and 2000 Guineas at Riccarton in early November. The Sarten will be the third career start for Quondo, the Wootton Bassett (Iffraaj) gelding won on debut at Matamata on September 12 before running second behind Sarten rival Magic Carpet (Satono Aladdin) in the Hawke's Bay Guineas (Gr 2, 1400m) at Te Rapa on September 27. "That was a very brave run in the Guineas," Forsman said. "He was caught wide without cover all the way and stuck on really well down the straight. I've been happy with him in between times, and if anything, I think he's improved." Virgo Viva tackles only her second start, after clearing maiden ranks over 1300m at Taupo on October 10. "To win the way she did on debut was a good effort," Forsman said. "The horse in front got away on her a little bit and she was still quite green. It was the first time she's been off the bridle and really asked to quicken, and she did a good job. It was the run of a horse that's going to get better and better with more racing. She's up against more experienced horses on Monday and from a wide barrier, so she's got a few things against her. But I think she's up there with them on ability."



HK: Mugen ready to strike again as Ng eyes Premier Bowl breakthrough

Pierre Ng is looking to Mugen (Deep Field) for a change of fortune in the Premier Bowl Handicap (Gr 2, 1200m) at Sha Tin on Sunday. A combination of factors could allow the seven-year-old to recapture the form that saw him post four wins and four placings during his five-year-old campaign, including solid race preparation and the installation of new headgear. Karis Teetan will once again take the ride and has been in the saddle for all of Mugen's wins. "His preparation has been good. He's had two trials with the blinkers on. He travelled better than he has done without them, so he'll be a lot closer," Ng said. "Last trial, he just didn't get a clear run, but he trialled on really well. Karis is very happy with him. So we're looking forward to Sunday." The fourth-year handler has endured an unusually slow start to the season with just one win to show for his 78 outings so far. But the 42-year-old, who was involved in one of the most dramatic title battles in recent memory during the 2023/24 campaign, losing the premiership to Francis Lui in the final race of the season, is hopeful Mugen can spur an upturn in his fortunes. The chestnut gelding appeared to have lost his way last season during a campaign that began with a failed assault on the Sprinters Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) at Nakayama and went unplaced in all six Hong Kong starts. "It took him a while [to recover] - after the Japan trip," Ng said. "He needed the time to get back in form. He went alright towards the end of last season, but he just needs some gear to help him now. So he's finally found his momentum again."

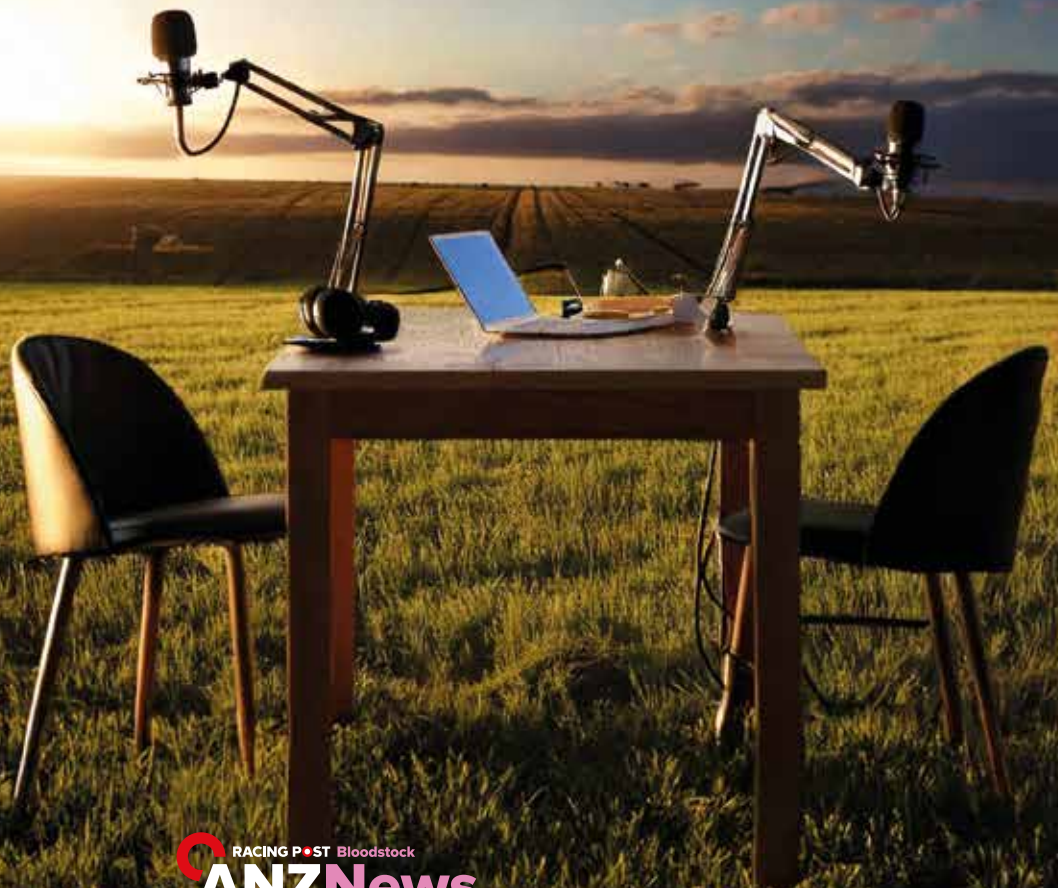

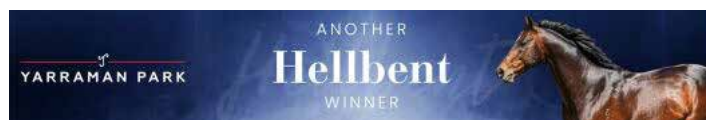
