Cosmic Crusader and Diamond Scene out to end four-year Group 1 drought for Peters

West Australian breeding icon Bob Peters is hoping to break what for him is a lengthy top-tier drought when he sends two runners into the final Australian elite-level contest of the year, the Northerly Stakes (Gr 1, 1800m) at Ascot on Saturday.

Things could not have gone better for Peters in 2021, when he swept the board of Perth's three top-level races, claiming the Railway Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) with Western Empire (Iffraaj), the Winterbottom Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m)

with Graceful Girl (Nicconi), and the Northerly with Regal Power (Pierro).

But those are the last Group 1s in which Peters' famed cerise with the white crossed sashes have crossed the line first. Coming shortly before he and long-term trainers Grant and Alana Williams parted company early in 2022, they're also the last time his horses have been placed in the city's three features.

However, Peters is hopeful his wait will be over this weekend with his two Michael Grantham-trained Northerly runners Cosmic Crusader (Maurice) and Diamond Scene (So You Think).

Air Assault poised for Ballarat Cup test

Connections of Air Assault (Justify) believe Saturday's Ballarat Cup (Listed, 2000m) could mark a pivotal moment in the career of the seven-time stakes winner as they weigh up his prospects as a potential 2026 weight-for-age performer. The gelding has yet to win beyond 1600 metres in five attempts, but Andrew Gluyas is confident that record reflects a horse on the cusp of maturation rather than a distance limitation. "That's his step, his challenge moving forward," Gluyas said of a potential weight-for-age future.

Cosmic Crusader was on Tuesday on the second line of betting at \$7, along with Peters' former runner Western Empire - who's still trained by Team Williams - and behind unbeaten three-year-old sensation King Of Light (Earthlight) at \$2.70.

Diamond Scene was around \$21 after coming home well last start when fourth in the Railway - the closest a Peters runner has come to an elite placing since his 2021 treble

While he's won a hatful of Group 1s and has stood as a giant among WA breeders for many years, Peters sounded decidedly mortal when he reflected: "Group 1s are very hard things to win."

"You might have a little run where you win a few of them and then you might go without for a while," he told ANZ News.

"We had a very good year in 2021, but I don't think we've had another Group 1 since then. Hopefully we can start winning them again."

Octogenarian Peters was, however, maintaining his usual realistic approach to

Saturday's race, conceding King Of Light would be "very hard to beat".

Still, not a betting man, he was pleasantly surprised to learn of Cosmic Crusader's high rank in the market.

"It's good to see other people like him," he said. "You've still got to see them do it, though."

Cosmic Crusader is the first of five foals to race for Cosmic Storm (Street Sense), who won four Perth stakes events for Peters, capped by the 2016 La Trice Classic (Gr 3, 1800m).

Peters, as is his way, has largely picked a stallion for the NSW-based broodmare and stuck to it. She's had eight matings, and seven have been with Cosmic Crusader's sire Maurice (Screen Hero).

The exception was one cover, just after Cosmic Crusader was born, from Windsor Park Stud shuttle Charm Spirit (Invincible Spirit), which explains why among Cosmic Storm's progeny, only Cosmic Crusader comes with an NZ suffix.

"We've produced nice foals by Maurice, so there's no reason not to go back to him," Peters said.

The luck hasn't run the best, however, with two misses and a deceased foal coming from Cosmic Storm's covers from Arrowfield's Japanese shuttler in the past four years.

She's in-foal to him again now though, with Peters keeping his fingers crossed. The Charm Spirit offspring - now a four-year-old named Cosmic Spirit - is looking handy too, if lightly raced, having won at Albany and Pinjarra in the past two of her three starts.



Cosmic Crusader stuttered somewhat early on, winning at starts one and three but not again in his first eight.

However, the gelding has boomed since the beginning of his preparation a year ago, a development that followed the removal of his visors.

He won both starts of that campaign in restricted grade, then made it four in a row at the start of the current one, still in benchmark affairs.

Promoted to stakes class, he ran an 0.28 length third in Ascot's Asian Beau Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) - won by subsequent Railway winner and \$9 Northerly chance Watch Me Rock (Awesome Rock) - before an 0.27 length third in the race named for his owner, the RJ Peters Stakes (Gr 3, 1500m).

While those efforts had merit, they were insufficient to secure a place higher than fourth emergency in the Railway. Cosmic Crusader instead went to the Carbine Club Stakes (Listed, 1400m) that day - and bolted in, by 2.59 lengths.

The five-year-old powered home from just behind midfield there, but has also led and come from the rear, depending on his barrier. Peters believes it will be a similar story this Saturday. Cosmic Crusader has drawn gate nine for jockey Clint Johnston-Porter.

Cosmic Crusader will need to be as good as the bookies feel he is on Saturday in what will be his initial attempt beyond 1650 metres, rising for the first time to weight-for-age - and 59 kilograms - from the 56.5 kilograms he had under the set weights of the Carbine Club.

But Peters hopes that with a decent pace set, his main hope will be powering home.

"I don't know what to think until he goes and does it," Peters said. "Sometimes in our races over here the pace goes off and horses don't handle that. He hasn't had the experience of running over this trip, so this is all new."

"It's also a bit different because unfortunately we didn't get a run in the Railway, and now he's got to go straight into weight-for-age. He got in well under the set weights in the Carbine Club, but now we're going to weight-for-age against proven weight-for-age horses."

"Put it this way, I think we'll know where we are with him after Saturday. I'm not confident he can win the race - he's coming up in grade enormously compared to everything he's done before - and King Of Light will be very hard to beat."

"But I think he'll get the distance alright, as long as he relaxes. A solid pace would be good."

Diamond Scene, in contrast, is already proven at the trip, with the six-year-old gelding having won at distances up to 2200 metres and run an 0.63 length second in last summer's Perth Cup (Gr 2, 2400m), behind \$51 Northerly chance Hemlock Stone (Dalghar).

The pair are en route to that New Year's Day feature again, but Peters said it wouldn't surprise him to see Diamond Scene turn in a strong performance this Saturday.

Diamond Scene is the seventh named foal of Peters' former mare Jewelled (Zabeel), who won just once but was second at 2200 metres in Listed class at Belmont.

Looking for some more stamina, Peters also stuck with So You Think (High Chaparral), putting Jewelled to him for five successive seasons. The product of the fourth mating - Diamond Scene - is now the mare's second stakes winner after Listed victor Adornment (Medaglia D'Oro).

"We sent mares to So You Think for a long time. It's a pity that he's gone now," said Peters, whose best runners by the Coolmore stallion - who died in October - include 2022 Perth Cup victor Midnight Blue.

Diamond Scene has won nine of 19 races, breaking through at stakes grade last summer with Ascot Listed wins over 1800 metres and 2200 metres.

The former, over the Northerly course, came two starts after a first-up 1400-metre success. He repeated that trick when resuming successfully in October's Eurythmic Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m), and also goes into Saturday's 1800-metre test third-up from a spell, following his fourth in the 1600-metre Railway.

"He came back in and surprised us in the Eurythmic, although it shouldn't have surprised us because he always runs well fresh," said Peters of a horse who's won three from four first-up.

"His Railway run was OK, just OK, but he's stepping up in distance now and that'll suit him. If he gets a good run he could be in the finish."

"But there's a weight-for-age race over 2100 metres for him at his next start, and that will probably be better for him than this one."



Air Assault poised for Ballarat Cup test

Connections of Air Assault (Justify) believe Saturday's Ballarat Cup (Listed, 2000m) could mark a pivotal moment in the career of the seven-time stakes winner as they weigh up his prospects as a potential 2026 weight-for-age performer. The gelding has yet to win beyond 1600 metres in five attempts, but Andrew Gluyas is confident that record reflects a horse on the cusp of maturation rather than a distance limitation. "That's his step, his challenge moving forward," Gluyas said of a potential weight-for-age future. "The way he's presented this prep physically, I think he's got every chance to make that step. Provided he stays sound, the way he's developing as an athlete, it gives him every chance to take that next step. We'll just see what happens on Saturday and maybe next year we'll go a different course with him." Air Assault was unplaced in last year's Ballarat Cup and carries 1.5 kilograms more (58 kilograms) this time, but Gluyas believes he returns a stronger, fresher version. "He was unplaced in the race last year, but he was on a long prep," the trainer told Racing.com. "He was up early for our [South Australian] weight-for-age races and he went to win the Balaklava Cup. It was a long prep and he raced well and ran second at Cranbourne [in the Cup behind Globe] but probably had enough by the time we got to this race. It's his fourth run in this time. We deliberately held him up for him to come through this back end so hopefully we've got that right."

Ballarat Cup on the agenda for Shaiyhar

The Trent Busuttin and Natalie Young-trained Shaiyhar (Camelot) looks set to tackle Saturday's Ballarat Cup, subject to his recovery from a gallop at Cranbourne on Tuesday and the weather at Ballarat this weekend. The last-start Listed third suffered a stone bruise last week but took in a

Packed Canterbury trials see plenty of eye-catchers

There were a total of six juvenile trials held at Canterbury on Tuesday, with the Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott-trained Lumbini (Russian Revolution) producing an eye-catching all the way effort for a 1.3 length success over Billecart Blue (Blue Point) in a time of 54.28s for the 895 metres.

Lumbini was the highest-priced yearling for her sire Russian Revolution (Snitzel) at January's Magic Millions sale when going to Glentree Thoroughbreds and Badgers Bloodstock for \$450,000. She is a sister to the stakes-placed winner Russian Conquest, being out of the US Grade 1-winning mare My Conquestadory (Artie Schiller).

Another trial of interest saw the John O'Shea and Tom Charlton-trained Born To Fly (I Am Invincible) score by 0.2 lengths over Behindcloseddoors (Home Affairs) in a time of 55.85 for the 900-metre trip.

The fifth foal out of the winning Flying Spur (Danehill) mare Rough Ride,

Born to Fly is a half-sister to Group-winning sprinters Eagle Nest (Shalaa) and Kalashnikov (Capitalist) and was a \$750,000 purchase for his trainers and James Bester Bloodstock at this year's Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale.

Breeders' Plate (Gr 3, 1000m) fourth Paradoxium (Extreme Choice) scored another impressive trial win as he ran out a 1.7 length winner of an 895-metre heat, defeating Steel Will (I Am Invincible) - himself a half-brother to dual Group 1 winner September Run (Exceed And Excel).

Paradoxium is the first foal out of the stakes-placed Better Than Ready (More Than Ready) mare Paredo, herself a half-sister to the dam of The Galaxy (Gr 1, 1100m) winner Private Harry (Harry Angel).

Meanwhile, Elio (Ole Kirk), another who has made one start to date when running fourth in the Max Lees Classic (900m) last month, produced a 1.2 length success over Gridlock (Home Affairs) in an 895-metre heat. The remaining juvenile heats were won by Campione D'italia (Snitzel) and By Choice (Written By).

gallop on Saturday before having another workout Tuesday morning. Shaiyhar finished third behind Kingswood (Roaring Lion) and Saint George (Roaring Lion) in the Ichiban Plate (Listed, 1800m) on November 4, and both could reoppose on Saturday. "He was good when he ran third in the Listed race at Flemington," Young said. "But he had a little bit of a stone bruise last week that was causing a bit of a concern. He galloped up good on Saturday and pulled-up nice and sound. We gave him a little more work on Tuesday, and we'll see how he is before making a final decision. He loves 2000 metres, which is a little bit further than last start and hopefully Ballarat is not a wash out like it has been in previous years. He doesn't like it too wet and hopefully the weather gods are in his favour." The Ballarat track was rated a Heavy 8 when nominations closed for the meeting on Monday.

Unbeaten King Of Light draws eight in Northerly Stakes

Northerly Stakes (Gr 1, 1800m) favourite King Of Light (Earthlight) has drawn barrier eight in his bid to make it six wins undefeated. The Dan Morton-trained son of Earthlight (Shamardal) was rated a \$2.70 chance on Tuesday having won his opening five outings, including a pair of Listed events and the WA Guineas (Gr 2, 1600m) in his last three. King Of Light will be the mount of leading WA jockey William Pike, and is stationed alongside \$7 second-elect Cosmic Crusader (Maurice), who drew gate nine, and close to \$8 chance Western Empire (Iffraaj) who will jump from barrier six.

Ninja could be Magic Millions bound

Progressive three-year-old Ninja (Farnan) has a pair of entries for this weekend as the Michael Freedman-trained gelding bids to prove whether he can make it to next month's Magic Millions meeting. The son of Farnan (Not A Single Doubt) ran third on debut at Randwick-Kensington in July before then scoring back-to-back victories, a maiden win at Kembla Grange on August 1 before a Benchmark 72 (1300m) success at Rosehill 15 days later. Ninja is nominated for another Benchmark 72 at Rosehill, this time over 1200 metres, while he could also line up in the Pierata Plate (1200m). "I just want to see the acceptances first, so I'm not really sure," Freedman said. "It'll

just depend on fields and barriers. I've seen enough of him on dry tracks. His trials this time back have both been on pretty firm ground, he seems pretty adept on all conditions. We'll sort of put him on a pathway perhaps towards a Magic Millions Guineas. See how he comes up, but that's sort of been a bit of a long-term program for him." Freedman is hoping to have Ninja lining up in the Magic Millions Guineas (RL, 1400m) third-up for the campaign. "If you went up there and raced Saturday, you may stay on and then run in a Vo Rogue [Plate] or something," the trainer said. "Second-up and then a fortnight into the Magic Millions, that's the type of program we'll be having a look at. But if we drew poorly in both on the weekend, then we've got the option of waiting and going to Wyong next week in that three-and-four-year-old race."

Well Written resumes with NZB Kiwi as major target

Unbeaten filly Well Written (Written Tycoon) is back in work, and while her exact summer path remains undecided, Stephen Marsh said discussions around her New Year programme are progressing. The \$4 million NZB Kiwi (1500m) at Ellerslie on March 7 is the clear aim, with Marsh confirming "that's the race she'll be targeting" though negotiations over which slot she will run for are set to intensify this week. "She's been back in the stable five days and looks great after having an easy time since the 1,000 Guineas," the trainer said. "This week there'll be a lot going on as we work through the various slots and other matters. We've asked all the interested parties to put their offers down in writing and by the end of the week we expect to be closer to making a decision as to where it lands. There's a lot in play between the owners and everyone else involved, but we'll get there, it's just a matter of working through the process." Marsh said a fresh-up tilt at the Sistema Railway (Gr 1, 1200m) is "less likely" with the Karaka Millions 3YO (RL, 1600m) or the Almanzor Trophy (Gr 3, 1200m) on January 24 shaping as stronger options. "We're tossing up whether we should run her fresh-up in the Railway or opt for her own age-group in the Almanzor Trophy," Marsh said. "The other option is to start her off earlier with a view to running in

the Karaka Millions. That's a possibility as she's done so well during her break and we're now wondering whether we run her in the Karaka Millions, then head to the Kiwi. Dropping back from 1600 to 1500 metres shouldn't be an issue, but there's a fair bit to weigh up."

Oratia Beauty eyes black-type targets

Oratia Beauty (Too Darn Hot) will get another opportunity to secure valuable black type at Ellerslie after her close second in Saturday's Trevor & Corallie Eagle Memorial 3YO (Listed, 1500m). The daughter of Too Darn Hot (Dubawi) produced a determined finish under Matt Cartwright to continue a strong start to her career, which now reads one win and four placings from six starts. "She jumped really well and it was a super ride by Matt, it was a great run," the filly's trainer Kylie Hoskin said. "Unfortunately, that other horse [Pulsatilla] got the rails run and went past us, but I thought our filly was very honest. She's really bright and did a bit of light work on Monday morning. She's nice and sound and comes through her races well, which is always a big help." Hoskin is weighing up two black-type options at Ellerslie over the holiday period. "We're looking at the Eight Carat on Boxing Day and we have also thought about the 2000-metre race [Sir Patrick Hogan Stakes] on New Year's Day," she said. "It's still up in the air and I have spoken to Matt and he thought maybe the mile might be better, but he also didn't think she would have trouble seeing out 2000 metres."

Hutchings returns for busy New Zealand summer

Expatriate jockey Rory Hutchings has resumed his successful "have saddle, will travel" approach, returning to New Zealand for another summer riding stint. The 30-year-old made a significant

impact last season with 14 wins from 100 rides, highlighted by the Herbie Dyke Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) and Fulton Family Stakes (Listed, 1500m) on El Vencedor (Shocking), as well as the Westbury Classic (Gr 2, 1400m) aboard the Chris Waller-trained Konasana (Dundeel). A long-time rider for the Waller stable, Hutchings recently completed a stint on the Gold Coast but has chosen to split time between family in Matamata and New Zealand's lucrative summer programme. His 2023-24 campaign was cut short by a collarbone fracture from a fall at Taupo, but he isn't deterred. "Hopefully I'll be able to recapitalise on what I did last summer," Hutchings said. "If I can do as well as I did then it would be great, and anything on top of that would be a bonus. I only flew in yesterday but I was kept busy at the Matamata track this morning riding work for a number of stables. I intend getting across to Cambridge later in the week, so like last year I'm hoping to keep busy and give myself the best chance." Hutchings now turns his focus to Saturday's Mufhasa Classic (Gr 1, 1600m) at Trentham. "I've been fortunate to pick up the ride on Ladies Man in the big race, so after what he did last year it would be great if he can make it back-to-back wins. I'm also riding Our Echo in the Spring Sprint and looking at his form, especially at Trentham, he should be a good ride too."

Whangaehu cleared to resume Group 1 path after Woodville trial

Bill Thurlow and Sam O'Malley are eyeing a return to elite company with Whangaehu (Proisir) following a satisfactory stewards-required trial at Woodville on Tuesday. The gelding had to trial after finishing eighth in October's Thompson Handicap (Gr 3, 1600m) at Trentham, where he was slow away and reluctant to stretch out early. Tuesday's 1000-metre heat delivered the response connections were seeking, with Whangaehu jumping cleanly and finishing fourth. "The main thing was we needed to get the tick of approval from

the stewards," O'Malley said. "He actually jumped away really well. He lacked a little bit of speed through the middle stages of the trial, but they were getting along pretty quickly on a good track. He really needs to go at least 2000 metres these days, so he was always going to be a bit outpaced over that trip, but he was working home nicely late. It's a bit hard to set a programme for him to get to some of the good races from here. We probably have to stick to weight-for-age now. The Zabeel Classic on Boxing Day might come up a little bit soon for him now, but it's a possibility, and then we'll try to follow through those other 2000-metre weight-for-age races through the rest of the summer."

[nine] again," Newnham said. "He lost focus in the straight the other day – he wanted to run out under pressure, so hopefully this [first-time cheek pieces] straightens him up a little bit." Lunar Dash won first-up prior to finishing second behind Run Run Smart (Dandy Man) on November 5. Newnham's four-year-old has one win from four starts, while the trainer has an unmatched 23 wins this season, four clear of nearest rival David Hayes (19). "There was a lot of interference in the race going into the first turn [last start], of which, he didn't suffer a lot of that, but he did race fairly tight for a fair distance. He's only a lightly raced horse, so he didn't cope particularly well," Newnham said.

Newnham has adapted to Hong Kong racing easily, posting 98 winners in the city after arriving ahead of the 2023/24 season. He saddles seven chances on Wednesday, led by lightly raced sprinter Lunar Dash's pairing with Zac Purton. "He's been consistent this season. He gets around the Valley well; he's done well since his last start, but he's come up with a difficult barrier

KOR: Hawk Wing dies of colic aged 26

Three-time Group 1 winner Hawk Wing (Woodman) has died aged 26 due to colic, according to reports in Japan. Trained by Aidan O'Brien throughout his career, he won the National Stakes (Gr 1, 7f) as a juvenile and finished runner-up behind two of his illustrious stablemates Rock Of Gibraltar (Danehill) and High Chaparral (Sadler's Wells) in the English 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1m) and Epsom Derby (Gr 1, 1m 4f) in 2002. He added a second Group 1 success to his record when a comprehensive winner of the Coral-Eclipse (Gr 1, 1m 2f) before filling the second place position again in the Irish and British versions of the Champion Stakes (Gr 1, 1m 2f) at Leopardstown and Ascot. As a four-year-old he enjoyed his finest moment when making all and pulling 11 lengths clear of Where Or When (Danehill Dancer) at Newbury in the Lockinge Stakes (Gr 1, 1m). Hawk Wing stood at Coolmore from 2004 to 2008 and ended his stallion career in Korea. In total he sired 15 individual stakes winners, headed by the elite-level winning pair Cambina and Stand To Gain, whose seven wins included a victory in the 2011 running of the Sydney Cup (Gr 1, 3200m).

'It's a phenomenal pedigree' - Japan Cup hero Calandagan's half-sister tops day one of December Mares at 850,000gns

It was standing room only inside the famous Park Paddocks auditorium for the first instalment of this year's Sceptre Sessions on Monday evening. Despite the big turnout in the ring, the lion's share of the action came online as Ace Stud spent 2,462,000gns on six new recruits.

The haul was headed by Overbury Stud's Caliyza (Le Havre), who topped the opening session of the December Mares Sale at 850,000gns (approx. AU\$1.8 million). The five-year-old daughter of Le Havre (Noverre) is from an Aga Khan Studs family that has garnered global headlines in recent days, as she is a half-sister to none other than Japan Cup (Gr 1, 2400m) hero Calandagan (Gleneagles).

That was the four-year-old's fourth top-level triumph following scores in the Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud (Gr 1, 2400m), King George VI And Queen Elizabeth Stakes (Gr 1, 1m 4f) and the Champion Stakes (Gr 1, 1m 2f).

Those elite victories have added considerable lustre to the page since Caliyza was purchased by Blandford Bloodstock's Richard Brown for 155,000gns at this sale last year. Added to the filly's appeal was the fact she was offered in foal to Gleneagles (Galileo), making the in-utero foal a close relation to Calandagan.

Monday was her third turn in the ring, having previously been sold by the Aga Khan Studs at the Arqana Breeding Stock Sale in 2023, where a €100,000 transaction saw her switch from Calandagan's trainer Francis Graffard to John McConnell.

"I'm lucky, I've got a wonderful farm that was laid down a long time ago," said Overbury's Simon Sweeting. "Everything is exactly as it should be. We have a fantastic team. They will do anything for the horses. We're hugely fortunate on that, they're sensational. And we have the right horses coming in. We've had some luck in the past month, it's all come together."

The transaction continued a fine run of form for Overbury, which co-bred this year's Dewhurst Stakes (Gr 1, 7f) scorer Gewan (Night Of Thunder) and then sold a Native Trail (Oasis Dream) half-brother to the youngster for 500,000gns (approx. AU\$1.05 million) during last week's December Foal Sale. Ace Stud also signed for that six-figure colt.

Expanding on Caliyza's backstory, Sweeting said: "She came here a year ago as a wildcard and, to be honest with you, it was an agent that worked a bit harder than everyone else and found her.

"When we were talking about it, we had no intention of selling her originally, Richard just said 'Look, we'll breed her to breed a racehorse.' Until the King George, we intended to keep her but after that, things changed. And then of course Sunday morning brought in a different dimension. It's great. It doesn't always work, but when it does it's great."

Ace Stud got the better of Northern Farm's buying team to secure Caliyza. The operation's racing and bloodstock manager Paul Curran said: "She has a three-parts [relation to Calandagan] in the belly so that makes a lot of sense, especially after the weekend."

"I wouldn't say that changed anything because he's already done what he's done, but it's a phenomenal pedigree and commercially you have a very good horse to come out of the belly. Delighted to get her but there's no immediate plans for her. We'll go back and reassess and digest tonight and sit down with everyone, especially the boss, and have a talk through them all."

Ace Stud's spree also took in the 650,000gns (approx. AU\$1.37 million) Amazonian (Sea The Stars), who was offered by Highclere Stud, and Town And Country (Earthlight), who fetched 600,000gns (approx. AU\$1.27 million) when presented by Castledillon Stud. The latter is set to visit Ace Stud's Shaquille (Charm Spirit), whose first foals created a big impression last week, while Amazonian is set to remain in training.

Town And Country's price represented a significant appreciation in value since her last visit to Park Paddocks, when the filly was secured by Windgates Stud at 160,000gns during the 2023 edition of Book 1. The filly was last seen carrying the colours of Ray Nolan and Mark Roden, who were among the crowd in Newmarket.

Town And Country won two of her eight starts for Henry de Bromhead, including this year's Scurry Stakes (Listed, 5f) at Sandown. With a furlong left to run she was travelling much the best but found herself boxed in behind a wall of horses. Despite meeting significant trouble in running she was able to get into the clear and ran on well to lead right on the post.

"We're delighted," said Roden. "We had mixed feelings about whether to let her go or not. Henry has done a marvellous job bringing her on over the last couple of years, winning the Scurry Stakes was a huge highlight, but we just felt now was the right time to let someone else have a bit of luck and breed from her."

"It's been great excitement. Ray is well used to a lot of excitement in business, but this is a different buzz. We really would've been happy to take her back, but she's gone for a fair value. We only have a couple in training and she was the only Flat runner, but we've ten mares at home at Windgates Stud."

Town And Country is the third foal out of Sweety Dream (Dream Ahead), who possessed plenty of talent herself, as she showed when landing the Prix Miesque (Gr 3, 1400m). The Dream Ahead (Diktat) mare has bred three winners from as many runners since retiring to the paddocks, and all three boast bold black type.

Her first foal is the Listed-winning Are We Dreaming (Kendargent), while her second is Godolphin's Romantic Style (Night Of Thunder), whose four victories include a defeat of Ramatuelle (Justify) in the Prix Imprudence (Gr 3, 1400m).

The four-year-old Amazonian made just a solitary start for Ralph Beckett and Isa Salman Al Khalifa, scoring in a Kempton novice stakes over a mile and three furlongs. The 350,000gns Book 2 yearling is a sibling to four winners, most notably her sister River Of Stars, a Group 3 winner and Group 1-placed performer who fetched 1,650,000gns from a buyer signing as Oakley Creek when offered at this sale 12 months ago.

River Of Stars was last seen carrying Zhang Yuesheng's colours into fourth behind Half Yours (St Jean) in the Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m). Her other siblings include the Listed-winning Apadanah (Holy Roman Emperor) and the Listed-placed Ancona (Amaron), along with the unraced Amazonka (Camelot), who is better known as the dam of Coventry Stakes (Gr

2, 6f) scorer Rashabar (Holy Roman Emperor).

"It's a family we know well and River Of Stars has done well this year," said Curran. "She ran really well in the Melbourne Cup and it's nice to get into the family again. There's no major plans with her and we'll probably keep her here, but it's nice to get into the family again."

Curran also confirmed that Seo Linn (Order Of St George), a classy dual purpose performer with useful form on the Flat and in bumpers was also part of the team's haul. The five-year-old daughter of Order Of St George (Galileo), who was offered by Paddy Twomey's Athassel House Stud, was knocked down to an online bid of 260,000gns (approx. AU\$550,600). The name Western Harbour International appeared on the ticket.

"She's very versatile in that she stays well enough to win a Grade 2 over two mile one, and she came back and won over a mile three this year," said Curran. "We've got the option to send her to Australia. I can't say where we're going to target her, but she looks like a very nice filly to target some of the staying races down there. She's a really nice-looking filly. She can go down a lot of avenues down there."

Diego date awaits 750,000gns Miss Justice

Two lots fetched 750,000gns (approx. AU\$1.58 million), led by the lightly raced Listed winner Miss Justice. The four-year-old daughter of Justify (Scat Daddy) was offered by Barton Sales and knocked down to Sam Sangster, acting on behalf of the partnership that are standing Prix Jacques le Marois (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Diego Velazquez (Frankel) at the National Stud.

"She's been bought by the partners and will go into training with Brian Meehan," said Sangster. "We'll carry on with her and probably cover her in training. She's still lightly raced and she's a gorgeous filly by Justify with a lovely pedigree, so there's a lot to look forward to. We really wanted to show the kind of quality we want to support Diego with."

"We'll regroup with Brian but there's a couple of Listed races coming up in December, we might target her at those, or we might think further afield. She's a fast ground filly so we can see if there's something for her in Dubai and then bring her back. When Diego gets going, hopefully he'll fancy her!"

Miss Justice was bred by Al Shahania Stud from the Zamindar (Gone West) mare Time Being. The Juddmonte pedigree is stacked with black type, as the dam is a sister to Falmouth Stakes (Gr 1, 1m) heroine Timepiece and a half-sister to Criterium de Saint-Cloud (Gr 1, 2000m) scorer Passage Of Time (Dansili). The latter name has also bred the likes of Time Test (Dubawi) and this year's Listed-winning and Irish 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1m) runner-up Cosmic Year (Kingman).

Miss Justice's previous visit to public auction saw her fetch €120,000 from Blandford Bloodstock on behalf of owners Wardley Bloodstock and partners.

The four-year-old did not make the track at two and raced only once at three, but has quickly made up for lost time. She won two of her eight starts for John and Thady Gosden, with a comfortable success in a Southwell novice event followed by a game triumph in the Upavon Stakes (Listed, 1m 2f).

She was last seen going down by just a neck to Karmology (Golden Horn) when runner-up in the Pride Stakes (Gr 3, 1m 2f) at Newmarket.

Northern Farm move for Rage Of Bamby

The second 750,000gns signing was the high-class sprinter Rage Of Bamby (Saxon Warrior), who was secured by the buying team from Katsumi Yoshida's Northern Farm.

The daughter of Saxon Warrior (Deep Impact) ran 20 times during her four seasons in training with Eve Johnson Houghton, winning five races along the way. She made a successful debut at Newbury during the summer of her two-year-old season and wasted no time in showing she was well above average. She followed up in a Leicester novice event before finishing third behind Commissioning (Kingman) in the Rockfel Stakes (Gr 2, 7f).

Her first black-type success came at the end of her four-year-old season, winning the Boadicea Stakes (Listed, 6f) at Newmarket. She produced her best effort on Racing Post Ratings at the age of five, taking out the Hackwood Stakes (Gr 3, 6f) in decisive fashion. That effort was allotted a mark of 115. Two starts later she reached the frame in Group 1 company, beaten just under two lengths into fourth in the Haydock Sprint Cup (Gr 1, 6f) won by Big Mojo (Mohaather).

"She looked very athletic and her action is very nice," said Northern Farm representative Shingo Hashimoto. "Her pedigree is strong and her mare line comes from the Miesque family, which is doing very well in Japan. We're very excited to take her home. We don't decide on mating plans until the mare is in heat and which stallion is available, but we'll figure out. She'll go to one of the better ones at our stud. Covering her in Europe is also an option but we won't decide until after Arqana."

He added: "It's a big factor for us to come here and buy bloodstock that we don't have in Japan. It's very important to diversify the bloodlines we have, that's why I come to Tattersalls each year. I'm always excited to come here and it's an important time of year."

Rage Of Bambu is from the debut crop of Saxon Warrior and is the third foal out of the Listed-placed Sakhee's Secret (Sakhee) mare Rabiosa Fiore. This makes her a sibling to three winners, including Amalaura (Raven's

Pass), a three-time Listed scorer in Italy. The page goes back to Niarchos champions East Of The Moon (Private Account), Alpha Centauri (Mastercraftsman) and Alpine Star (Sea The Moon).

Rage Of Bambu had been to the sales on one previous occasion when realising €35,000 from Marco Bozzi at the SGA Yearling Sale in Milan back in 2021.

She raced for a partnership of the Hot To Trot Racing syndicate and Antoinette Kavanagh of Kildaragh Stud, who consigned the mare on Monday.

"I bought her in Milan as a yearling," said Kildaragh's Peter Kavanagh. "I only saw her on video, I loved her head and outlook. And you could see that again today, she showed liked a champ and behaved perfectly. We bought a fair bit of the family subsequently; we bought the half-sister [Rinnovati] in Milan the following year that topped the sale [at €200,000]. It's lovely to have some of the family, it's lovely to

have raced her, she's taken us on a fabulous journey. Hot To Trot were great partners and we had a lot of fun together."

Monday's session saw 21,451,000gns (approx. AU\$45.42 million) change hands, which was down seven per cent year on year. The average price was 96,195gns (approx. AU\$203,710), which was also down seven per cent, while the median dipped six per cent to 47,000gns (approx. AU\$99,530). The clearance rate was 85 per cent as 223 lots sold from 262 offered.

The December Mares Sale was set to continue on Tuesday, with day two starting at 9.30am (GMT). The second instalment of the Sceptre Sessions includes Group 1-winning fillies Barnavara (Calyx), Choisya (Night Of Thunder), Porta Fortuna (Caravaggio) and Tamfana (Soldier Hollow), along with Suelita (Dutch Art), dam of Chaldean (Frankel), who is being offered carrying a full-sibling to the Dewhurst and English 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1m) winner.
