McEvoy's chasing further stakes glory in trio of states

The in-form Calvin and Tony McEvoy stable will look to extend their stakes-winning run on Saturday as they launch a tri-state raid, saddling two stakes-placed juveniles and a Pakenham Cup (Listed, 2500m) hopeful across Sydney, Brisbane and Victoria.

At Randwick, the Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m)-winning father-and-son partnership will chase Inglis Nursery (RL, 1000m) honours with Bohemian Rhapsody (Prague), who debuted with a strong third in the Inglis Banner

(RL, 1000m) and now heads north in search of a breakthrough stakes win.

"He has trained on well," Calvin McEvoy told ANZ News. "He's been up to Albury and had a trial on the Sydney leg, which we were keen to see him on that leg. He handled that nicely, then went back to Flemington and trained on well, so it all looks pretty peachy."

A \$4 chance, the colt has drawn the inside gate with Tim Clark aboard, and McEvoy hopes his race experience proves decisive.

"He's drawn well with Tim Clark on board. We quite like the horse, so I'm looking forward to seeing where he sits," he said. **Cont. on page 2**

"I'm not sure he's a real speed horse, but from that barrier with an on-speed rider, we'll just be asking Tim to get him out the gates and then for him to work it out, ride him where he's comfortable. He's got the race experience on a couple of these."

Bought for \$200,000 by McEvoy Mitchell Racing and Damon Gabbedy's Belmont Bloodstock from Sledmere Stud's Inglis Classic draft, the colt is the second foal out of Kris Lees' dual Group 2 winner Invincible Gem (I Am Invincible), who captured the Missile Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) and finished Group 1-placed in the Canterbury Stakes (Gr 1, 1300m).

"He's a beautiful horse, very good looking colt. We weren't sure about Prague, but we love the pedigree, we love the dam side, and on his physical type, we were very pleased to be taking him home," McEvoy said.

Further north at Eagle Farm, the stable will saddle short-priced favourite One Day At A Time (Bivouac) in the Widden's Jacquinot First Yearlings 2026 (1000m).

The filly, who ran third in the Maribyrnong Trial Stakes (Listed, 1000m) on debut in October, is building towards a Magic Millions 2YO Classic (RL, 1200m) tilt and McEvoy believes she can take another step.

"She's a beautiful Bivouac filly," he said. "I think she was quite unlucky not to win the stakes race. She just had to get back, got into a lot of trouble and was beaten half a length.

"She trialled nicely up there and we think a fair bit of her. So on that, we expect her to be very hard to beat taking on a couple of winning two-year-olds, but we've got plans to try and run her in the Magic Millions, should she be going well."

Purchased for \$270,000 from Rosemont Stud's Magic Millions draft by the same connections who acquired Bohemian Rhapsody, the filly will jump from barrier six under Ryan Maloney.

"I would expect there to be good pace. I think she can probably settle wherever. She's pretty tractable. She's a filly that will get better over a bit further so a 1000 metres is probably right at the shorter, sharper end of her scale," McEvoy added.

Meanwhile, in their home state the camp will be represented by Cavity Bay (Cable Bay) in the Pakenham Cup.

Racing in the famed silks of champion mare Makybe Diva (Desert King), the four-year-old mare has been consistent all preparation and arrives ready for a rise in trip.

"She's going really well," McEvoy said. "She's been quite frustrating only winning the one race, but Tony Santic [owner] was keen to have a crack at the race and she's sound, fit and well."

A multiple stakes placegetter, Cavity Bay gets her chance again over a staying journey with Harry Coffey taking the ride.

"We are looking forward to seeing how she handles getting back up to this trip. She's run very well in both the South Australian Derby [fifth] and the SA Fillies Classic [third] over the 2500 metres. So, the distance shouldn't be a concern and look, she'll run better than her odds," he said.

"I would have preferred her to draw in, but it is what it is. They've got a long way to find a position [from barrier 12]. So she's a mare that relaxes quite well. So we expect her to be able to hopefully slot in, get some cover and be produced late."

Yorkshire bidding for The Ingham glory

Last-start Festival Stakes (Gr 3, 1500m) winner Yorkshire (Snitzel) will bid to hand his trainer John O'Shea a fourth career success in Saturday's The Ingham (Gr 2, 1600m) at Randwick. O'Shea celebrated his first Group win as a trainer in his own right 25 years ago when Grey And Gold (Danehill) triumphed in the Villiers Stakes, winning it again three years later with On A High (Pauillac) before then landing its first incarnation as The Ingham in 2022 with Kirwan's Lane (Charm Spirit). O'Shea, who now trains in partnership with Tom Charlton, is hoping that Yorkshire can back up his last-start Group 3 success as he steps up further in grade this weekend. "Obviously, a lot of water has gone under the bridge, but it's a race that has always been very dear to me and let's hope we can be competitive again," O'Shea said. "He [Yorkshire] is probably the most accomplished horse we've run in it, apart from It's Somewhat but It's Somewhat had 59 kilos. This horse has ended up very well weighted [53 kilograms] and probably has the best record of any horse we've run in it. It's a decent race on Saturday. You've got progressive, lightly weighted chances and multiple heavyweight chances. Gringotts would be competitive in any Doncaster [Mile]. Sabaj looks to have great form. Estadio Mestalla has great form. There's a Caulfield Cup winner [Duke De Sessa] in there. It's a pretty strong race."

Lees with runners in three Randwick stakes races

Kris Lees will send out runners in a trio of the stakes races on Saturday's Randwick card. Lees has won The Ingham twice with Loch Eagle (Lonhro) (2023) and Sense Of Occasion (Street Sense) (2016), and the Razor Sharp Handicap (Listed, 1200m) with Special Reward (Demerit) (2021) and Zestful (Redoute's Choice) (2017). He will again go for glory in those contests as Brudenell (Russian

Stakes-producing mares and share in Within The Law headline December (Late) Online Sale

Stakes-producing mares, several well-credentialed racing and breeding prospects and a share in Group 1 performer Within The Law (Lucky Vega) are among the highlights of the Inglis Digital December (Late) Online Sale, which is now open for bidding.

Stop Making Sense (Sebring) is the dam of this year's Caulfield Classic (Gr 3, 2000m) winner Autumn Mystery (The Autumn Sun) and is offered as a three-in-one package, in foal to I Am Invincible's (Invincible Spirit) first Group 1-winning two-year-old in Move To Strike and with a Flying Artie (Artie Schiller) colt at foot.

Merry Angelore (Smart Missile) is a sister to Group 3 winner Aviatress and is offered carrying to popular young stallion Castelvechio (Dundeel), who was fully booked at a fee of \$49,500 (inc GST) at Arrowfield Stud this season.

Deadly Desire (Super Seth) is a lightly

raced mare being offered as a racing and breeding prospect in the sale. The four-year-old is a half-sister to Group 1 scorer Ruthless Dame (Tavistock) and juvenile stakes winner Torture (Sword Of State) and is herself a winner from just five career starts to date.

Meanwhile, a 2.5 per cent share in Within The Law is another intriguing entry in the catalogue. A \$30,000 Inglis Classic Yearling Sale purchase for Darby Racing, the mare is already a winner of \$1.7 million in prize-money courtesy of three stakes victories and twice being placed at Group 1 level.

Trilogy Racing is offering an unreserved reduction featuring racehorses, yearlings, broodmares and racehorse shares. Among the 23 entries is a five per cent share in Golden Slipper (Gr 1, 1200m) runner-up Coleman (Pierata), multiple three-in-one packages and three Sejardan (Sebring) yearlings.

In total the December (Late) sale consists of 295 entries - 124 racehorses (53 race fillies), 89 racehorse shares, 53 broodmares, 17 yearlings, nine unraced stock and three two-year-olds. To view the catalogue click [here](#).

Revolution) lines up in the latter contest, and Loch Eagle is joined by Tavi Time (Tavistock) and You Whang (So You Think) in The Ingham. Brudenell has been beaten less than a length at his past two starts, most recently when third in The Hunter (1300m) at his home track. "He's up in the weights a bit these days but he's had four weeks between runs, and he races well like that," Lees said. "He was good in The Hunter. It's probably a slight drop in grade and he needs the right run from a tricky gate [13], albeit it's not the worst start at Randwick." On his Ingham runners, Lees added: "Tavi Time doesn't need the rain, Loch Eagle needs the rain and You Whang, she probably needs a bit of luck from the gate [21]. She may also need one more run. She is going well, and she is being targeted at the Magic Millions." Age Of Sail (Frankel) rounds out Lees' stakes runners in the Christmas Cup (Listed, 2400m) after a last-start fourth to Saturday's rival Asterix (Tavistock) in The Beauford (2300m) at Newcastle. "It looks a nice race for him," Lees added.

Gibbons relishing Razor Sharp test with Brave One

Dylan Gibbons is looking forward to seeing how Brave One (Exceedance) can match up to some classy rivals when he lines up in Saturday's Razor Sharp Handicap at Randwick. The Team Hawkes-trained four-year-old gelding has four wins and three further placings from just nine outings and, after finishing second first-up for this campaign, landed a Benchmark 94 (1300m) last time out at Newcastle, prompting this weekend's step up in grade. "I went a lot quicker than I would have liked so he had to show how much ability and how tough he was," Gibbons told Racing NSW of Brave One's latest start. "The way it panned out he was never going to be quick late and was probably entitled to be sniped late. It's obviously a step up but I like the way he's won his previous races, he's been well placed but he feels to me he just does what he needs to do. He keeps raising the bar once they put a new challenge in front of him. I think at the Randwick 1200 metres we just keep it simple. He jumped well the other day and I gave him a bit of a squeeze and had him in a bit of a speed duel so I don't want to fire him up again. The 1200 metres is a great start to cop drawing wide, whether I'm three deep or they

string out and I'm one off so be it. It doesn't matter too much. He gets some nice weight relief which is good. I like him at 1200 metres because he was a bit keen the other day. It'll be interesting to see how he measures up against some handier horses."

Christmas Cup for Hollywood Hero

The Bjorn Baker-trained Hollywood Hero (Sacred Falls) will step beyond 2000 metres for the first time in his career at start number 36 as the six-year-old gelding tackles Saturday's Christmas Cup at Randwick. The son of Sacred Falls (O'Reilly) had only been beyond a mile once prior to the beginning of this preparation, but is now set for 2400 metres after producing an excellent third-placed effort in the ATC Cup (Listed, 2000m) last time out. "It's funny how things evolve, but you look at options and we think that's his best chance," Baker told Racing NSW. "It'll be interesting but we definitely think he can run a big race. His work has been sensational going into it so from that point of view I'm confident he can run a good race. He just needs to be put in the comfort zone and up over 2400 metres he may be able to sit a bit closer without too much pressure. He's been a good horse, he's been consistent and in some ways he deserves a stakes win."

Browne's hoping for Pakenham Cup success

David and Emma-Lee Browne are hopeful that Statuario (D'Argento) can get his head back in front after a period of consistent efforts. The four-year-old gelding last won in April this year when landing the Galilee Series Final (Listed, 2400m) at Flemington, and has since produced placed efforts in races such as the South Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2500m), Heatherlie Stakes (Listed, 1700m) and a last-start third in the Ballarat Cup (Listed, 2000m) behind Berkeley Square (Territories). "It would be great to win the local Cup," Emma-Lee Browne said. "And I reckon the party at the Garfield pub would be wild. It's nice to have runners on the day and being from the area, hopefully it's a good day." Browne feels that Statuario could already have had a cup win under his belt had he got more luck in running at Ballarat on December 6. "It was one of those unfortunate

races at Cranbourne where he couldn't get out and there was little he could do about it," she said. "He was much better the other day, but he probably just cost himself late because of that Cranbourne run, he just peaked late, but given that, we probably wouldn't be here if he'd had two hard runs in a row. The horse is very well. We're very happy with how he came through Ballarat, but we don't want to see too much rain on Saturday, so we're watching the weather quite closely. We would have liked a slightly more economical draw, but it probably forces our hand to ride him quietly and I think that is sometimes when he's at his best."

Jenni The Fox on hunt for The Supanova

Having run fourth in The Meteorite (1200m) last time out on November 22, Jenni The Fox (Too Darn Hot) will again take up her place in the other of Southside Racing's slot races when she takes on Saturday's The Supernova (1400m) at Pakenham. Trained by Lucy Yeomans, the four-year-old daughter of Too Darn Hot (Dubawi) came home strongly in The Meteorite and her Cranbourne-based trainer feels the best is yet to come from the mare back up in trip. She will run in the slot held by her owner Tony Ottobre's Cape Schanck Racing. "I think she is a serious horse, and we will see the best of her in six to 12 months," Yeomans said. "She can run a very quick sectional, the 1400 metres will suit, but there is a little query on the track as it has been a little sticky and if the rain comes, it might take the shine off her, but everyone is in the same boat. She's a beautiful horse to train because you know on race day she will turn up and give you her best in any conditions and every time we run her, she keeps raising the bar. This is a tougher task again, so she will need to raise that bar again. We're not confident [of the win] by any stretch, but I am confident she will run well."

Lonhro's Queen aiming for reversal in Just Now

Lonhro's Queen (Lonhro) will bid to turn the tables on her last-start conqueror Midnight In Tokyo (Kobayashi) when the pair clash in Saturday's Just Now Stakes (Listed, 1300m) at Eagle Farm on Saturday. The Chris and Corey Munce-trained mare finished 1.7 lengths behind the Annabel and Rob Archibald-trained Midnight In Tokyo in the Tattersall's Classic (Listed, 1200m) at Doomben on November 29, but finds herself 5.5 kilograms better off in this weekend's Listed contest. "There's a big turnaround in the weights which favour our mare," Corey Munce told Racing Queensland. "Our main reservation is whether she can run out the 1300 metres. Her last run suggests she should get the trip so we're planning to ride her a bit quieter this time. Martin [Harley] is our lucky jockey and he always makes good decisions. Her work on Tuesday morning was very good and Martin was impressed with her. She's a promising mare who keeps improving."

Jimmystar's younger brother to make debut

In'kantosstar (Per Incanto), a brother to multiple Group 1 winner Jimmysstar, will make his debut on Saturday when he lines up in an 1100-metre contest at Moe. Just like Jimmysstar, In'kantosstar was bred by Pete and Chrissy Algie and Little Avondale Stud and is trained by Ciaran Maher and will race in Ozzie Kheir's silks. The three-year-old gelding is also owned by many of Jimmysstar's connections, including Kheir, John O'Neill, Williams and Mat Becker. "For us, sentiment almost never comes into it. We very rarely go and buy the siblings of our good horses," Becker, whose Group 1 Bloodstock purchased the gelding for \$260,000 at the 2024 Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale, told Racing.com. "We look at every horse as an individual. We don't try to chase the brothers or sisters with the hope they may be good, because the odds are they won't be as good as what you've got. We're always looking for the next good horse. He's trialled well, they've been very controlled. Jimmy[sstar] didn't race until he was four and I find the Per Incantos improve with time. Occasionally, you'll get one like Little Brose that is up early. This horse was physically immature and we elected not to run him at two."

He spent a lot of time in the paddock, developing and he's really just learning the ropes now as a three-year-old. It may be short of his best trip and he may be a bit green and new, but he has trialled well and the feedback from the stable has been pretty positive. I think he's got a good level of ability and I do think he is a horse to follow. Whatever he does on Sunday, he will improve on."

Tower Bridge breaks maiden

Highly regarded colt Tower Bridge (I Am Invincible) recorded a stylish second start maiden victory in the Transom Marine Services Maiden (1230m) at Geelong on Friday. Having run a 4.6 lengths fourth on debut at Caulfield Heath, the Mark Walker-trained three-year-old improved on that to score by 3.5 lengths over Col Klink (Rich Enuff) on Friday under Lachlan Neindorf. "It was a good effort to travel like he did in front and quicken up like a really nice horse in the making," said trainer Mark Walker. "We'd been tinkering with his gear and we got it right today, after Ben [Gleeson, assistant trainer] and I had experimented a bit in training with him. We decided to use his high cruising speed and he went along at a nice gallop, but he really quickened up when Lachlan [Neindorf] asked him to, and it should give him a lot of confidence to go on with it. I think we'll look for a city class race for him, now, but great to have a promising horse like him win in the famous Coolmore Stud colours, and the powerful ownership, and I'm very grateful for all the support that Coolmore has given us since we arrived in Melbourne." Tower Bridge was bought by Coolmore and Te Akau for \$1.3 million from the Yarraman Park draft at the 2024 edition of the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale. He is a brother to Group 2 winner Shuffle Dancer.

Stackhouse ruled out for several weeks

Daniel Stackhouse will be out of the saddle for several weeks after sustaining injuries at trackwork on Tuesday. Stackhouse took four rides at Sandown-Lakeside on Wednesday, and rode a winner for Reece Goodwin (Primal Spirit), but increasing discomfort led to him seeking medical treatment. He was diagnosed as having three stable transverse fractures between L3 and L5, along with two internal haematomas in the surrounding area. The injuries are stable and do not require surgery, however, Stackhouse expects to be sidelined for at least the next few weeks. "I aim to return to race riding before the new year," he wrote on social media. "I appreciate the support from my team, medical staff, and everyone who has reached out."

Forbes case settled out of court

The Fair Work Commission legal dispute over bullying allegations brought by Racing Victoria's chief vet Dr Grace Forbes against CEO Aaron Morrison and other senior executives has been settled out of court, the Herald Sun reported on Friday. Forbes had claimed that Racing Victoria staff, including Morrison, manager of people and performance Xavier Linton and executive general manager - integrity services Jamie Stier, had tried to coerce her into allowing horses with high risk scans to be passed fit to run in the Spring Carnival.

New Zealand

Ladies Man retired

Dual Group 1 winner Ladies Man (Zed) has been retired. Bred by Grangewilliam Stud, Ladies Man, a son of their resident stallion Zed (Zabeel), was the younger half-brother to Auckland Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) winner Ladies First, and like his older sibling, he joined the New Plymouth barn of Allan Sharrock and quickly showed his propensity for racing, placing in his first two starts as a three-year-old before winning his maiden over 1400 metres. He continued his upward trajectory, winning a further three races before placing in the Marton Cup (Listed, 2200m) as a five-year-old and

broke through for his maiden stakes victory at his next start in the Trentham Stakes (Gr 3, 2100m). He added further stakes placings to his record before winning the Livamol Classic (Gr 1, 2040m). He also placed in last year's Bonecrusher New Zealand Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) before doubling his elite-level tally in the Mufhasa Classic (Gr 1, 1600m) at Trentham last December. He placed in September's Howden Insurance Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) and subsequently ticked over the \$1 million mark in earnings before the curtain was brought down on his career after tailing the field home in last Saturday's Mufhasa Classic. In all, the now eight-year-old gelding won eight and placed in 16 of his 39 career starts. "He has been officially retired," Sharrock said. "We have battled with him [foot issues] for a couple of years and it's not getting any better, so we have pulled pin on his career. He has done a good job, but it just got too hard. His rating is so high (105), and you can't run him in a handicap for the weight he gets and he is probably not quite at the level to win the weight-for-age Group 1s now. He has been a great horse to us, he has won over \$1 million and two Group 1s. You have got to make a call and he has done a great job and will find a lovely home."

Hollinshead chasing family Cup double

Darrell Hollinshead's bid for a second success in Saturday's Waikato Cup (Gr 3, 2400m) has been dealt a blow, but he remains in the hunt to turn back the clock. The Te Awamutu trainer won the staying feature 19 years ago with Bak Da Chief (Chief Bearhart) and had expected to have two runners in this weekend's event at Te Rapa. However, his hopes will now solely rest on Rosetown Princess (Redwood) with stablemate Ramblin' Rose (Complacent) ruled out by injury. With luck in the running, he is expecting a strong showing from Rosetown Princess who hails from the same family as Bak Da Chief. The 2006 cup winner also found fame in retirement as the dam of two-time Group 1 winner Te Akau Shark (Rip Van Winkle) while a half-sister produced the Easter Handicap (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Pondarosa Miss (High Chaparral) and multiple stakes winner and top-flight placegetter Ecuador (High Chaparral).

"The hardest thing for Rosetown Princess will be that draw [barrier 16] because she needs a bit of cover," Hollinshead said. The daughter of Redwood (High Chaparral) was narrowly beaten two runs back in the Counties Cup (Gr 3, 2100m) at Pukekohe and was then unplaced on the course when she dropped back in grade. "She got cut off at the start and she ended up last and had that big weight [60 kilograms], she was only four lengths off the winner, so it wasn't a bad run," Hollinshead said. "She has trained on well since and drops back to 53 kilograms on Saturday so that helps. I might give her a break after this, she's been up a long time and she's very versatile, she can go on all ground and always tries."

Cantabrian chasing back-to-back Southland Crystals

Stakes performer Smooth Operator (Turn Me Loose) hasn't had the best of luck over the last month, but trainer Stephanie Faulkner believes he is back on track to defend his title in Saturday's Southland Crystals (2200m) at Ascot Park. The six-year-old gelding headed into New Zealand Cup Week in solid form, having finished fourth in the Spring Classic (Listed, 2000m) at Riccarton in October, but he was disappointed over the Cup carnival, finishing tenth and 13th respectively in the Metropolitan Trophy (Listed, 2600m) and New Zealand Cup (Gr 3, 3200m). Things only got worse for the son of Turn Me Loose (Iffraaj), who suffered a bacterial infection, but Faulkner said he is now back to full health and ready to fire in his resuming run. "You can rule a line through the New Zealand Cup," Faulkner said. "He had a bacterial infection since, he had a bit of gunk in the bottom of his lungs, but he seems pretty good with that now." Smooth Operator has a strong record at Ascot Park, winning

two and placing in two of his five starts at the Invercargill track, and Faulkner is hoping he can build on that form this weekend. "It is all up to him really. He is definitely up to it if he has his mind in the right place," Faulkner said. "He seems to race well at Invercargill. I think he likes the overnight trip away. He is a big, strong horse so he probably won't even feel Rohan on his back."

No NZB Kiwi slot decisions yet for Gerard pair

With NZB Kiwi favourite Well Written (Written Tycoon) confirmed to run in the Entain/TAB NZ slot in New Zealand's richest race, attention is now being focused on decisions around other prominent candidates for the \$4 million March 7 feature. Those horses include the Pam Gerard-trained New Zealand 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) quinella pair Romanoff (Belardo) and Affirmative Action (Yes Yes Yes). "No decision has been made yet on either horse," Gerard said. "As the 2,000 Guineas winner, Romanoff has first option on the Canterbury Jockey Club slot and those negotiations are still taking place between the horse's connections and the CJC." Gerard reports that her star three-year-old pair are making pleasing progress back in full work following some time out to recover from their trip south. "They're back in the stable and doing well, I'm very pleased with them both for what's shaping as an exciting summer. What we have penciled in at this stage is for Affirmative Action to run in the Auckland Guineas at Ellerslie on Boxing Day, and Romanoff will have his first start back in the Levin Classic at Trentham on the first Saturday in January. That way the first time they'll meet again will be the Karaka Millions 3YO at the end of January and all going to plan they'll then target the Kiwi."

Bright future tipped for well-bred Day One

A bright future is being tipped for well-bred three-year-old Day One (Wootton Bassett) following his maiden victory in the Barfoot & Thompson 1600 (1600m) at Ellerslie on Thursday. He had shown a lot of promise at the trials before running fifth on debut over 1400 metres at Arawa Park last month, and trainers Mark Walker and Sam Bergerson had

been pleased with his subsequent progress. He jumped away well from his wide gate on Thursday, but there was plenty of speed inside him and jockey Opie Bosson was forced to ease his charge back to sit midfield. At the 600 metres, Bosson followed race favourite Arthur (Camelot) three-wide and presented his charge at the turn and Day One showed a good turn of foot in the concluding stages to score a 1.3 lengths success over Fly Zenno (Ancient Spirit). "It was a really good effort, especially after not getting all favours in running, but Opie didn't panic and the horse produced a big effort to win," Walker said. "I think he would have learned a lot from the experience and he quickened up like a nice horse. He's a big, scopey type of horse with a lot of raw ability, which we saw today, and he'll only get better as we step him up in distance. I loved the way he relaxed and then quickened so well in the straight. Obviously he's very well bred and it's great to get another win for Lib Petagna and the Elsdon Park team in Matamata."



HK: Eustace upbeat on Docklands

The Harry Eustace-trained Docklands (Massaat) will tackle Sunday's Hong Kong Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) at Sha Tin as he bids to bounce back from a ninth placing in the Mile Championship (Gr 1, 1600m) at Kyoto last month – his first start since finishing fourth in the Queen Elizabeth II Stakes (Gr 1, 1m) at Ascot in October. The now five-year-old entire took out the Queen Anne Stakes (Gr 1, 1m) on the opening day of Royal Ascot in June, and will be taking on the likes of local heroes Voyage Bubble (Deep Field) and My Wish (Flying Artie). "The Japanese experience was fantastic but hard," Eustace said. "The competition and

the travelling for him was hard and we weren't helped by drawing 16 of 18. I was delighted with the run and he has really bounced out of it well. He looked super this morning and I think we'll run a solid race on Sunday. He is mentally tough and the first time you travel horses you never know how they will handle it. He travelled ok last year but he has definitely taken it better this year."

HK: McDonald banking on Galaxy Patch repeat in Hong Kong Mile

The stars aligned for James McDonald when he partnered Galaxy Patch (Wandjina) for the first time in the Jockey Club Mile (Gr 2, 1600m) last month, and the rider is hoping a similar scenario can play out in the Hong Kong Mile on Sunday. The duo has a perfect record going into this weekend's contest after the six-year-old put in a powerful finish up the inside rail to defeat Sunlight Power (Capitalist), Happy Together (Dragon Pulse) and My Wish last time. All three runners re-oppose at the weekend to form a strong local challenge. It was Galaxy Patch's first victory since the Sha Tin Trophy Handicap (Gr 2, 1600m) in October, 2024, but he has always threatened to develop into a top-level performer and McDonald's assistance could prove the key. "I was very impressed with him and his trial afterwards was even more impressive," the rider said in a press conference at Sha Tin Racecourse. "I thought he was brilliant coming out of that race. We've always known he's a very good horse, he just hasn't had the rub of the green at times due to his racing style, but he's as good a horse as any of them and he just needs luck to go his way. It's a big field and he's going to need pace on because he gets back, but he's definitely capable of running over the top of them. He's up to this level and he gives you a good feel."

HK: Arc third Sosie lining up in Vase for Fabre

Down the years, Andre Fabre has proved himself a master at identifying the right horses to send to the Hong Kong Vase (Gr 1, 2400m), boasting a remarkable record of three wins and five placed efforts from 21 starters, dating back to a victorious debut at the meeting with Borgia (Acatenango) in 1999. Third in the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe (Gr 1, 2400m) on his most recent start, Sosie (Sea The Stars) is arguably a match for any of his predecessors from the stable. Sosie has enjoyed a fine season, opening with a pair of Group 1 victories at short of his best trip when landing the Prix Ganay (Gr 1, 2100m) and the Prix d'Ispahan (Gr 1, 1850m) back in the spring. Returning to 2400 metres after a midseason break, Sosie ran an eye-catching trial when second to Byzantine Dream (Epiphaneia) in the Prix Foy (Gr 2, 2400m), form he reversed when third in the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe itself, leaving his old rival back in fifth, and edging a place on the podium at the expense of fellow Hong Kong Vase contender and 2024 winner Giavellotto (Mastercraftsman). Both horses will be much more at home on the expected fast turf at Sha Tin on Sunday, and Fabre has been encouraged to head to Hong Kong by the way Sosie has maintained his form post-Arc. "He did a good piece of work at Saint-Cloud and since then he has done some canters," Fabre said. "He looks alright and they are happy with him



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in Hong Kong. Sosie looks a good fit for this race and he might stay in training next year, we'll see what Sunday brings. The good ground should suit him and the track at Sha Tin is perfect for him. It's a very fair course and there is usually a strong pace so any horse should be able to show his best form there."

International

UK: Coolmore announce Coronation Cup sponsorship, Derby prize increased

Next year's Epsom Derby (Gr 1, 1m 4f) will be worth £2 million (approx. AU\$4.01 million) as part of a £6 million (approx. AU\$12.03 million) investment by the Jockey Club to reinvigorate Epsom and Britain's premier Classic, with the aim of attracting a crowd of 100,000 for the festival by 2030. As well as boosting prize-money for the Derby by £500,000 (approx. AU\$1 million) and extending pay-outs down to tenth place, Epsom has also moved the Coronation Cup (Gr 1, 1m 4f) back to the Saturday of the fixture, when it will be worth £1 million (approx. AU\$2 million) (up from £450,000) and sponsored by Coolmore. "The Group 1 Coolmore Coronation Cup will move to now be run on Derby Day. Its total prize-money will raise significantly to £1 million. We must say a huge thank you to Coolmore – and in particular Derek Smith, Michael Tabor and John Magnier – for their huge support of the Betfred Derby Festival. Their commitment plays a vital role in elevating the quality and global appeal of the Coolmore Coronation Cup," a statement from the Jockey Club read. Coolmore's leading trainer Aidan O'Brien welcomed the news of investment. "From the time that matings are planned at Coolmore, right the way through to the training process here at Ballydoyle, there is always huge emphasis placed on the Derby," the Ballydoyle maestro said. "If we had to pick one race in the calendar to win, the Derby would invariably be it. We are very grateful to the Jockey Club for their increased investment for next year's Derby Festival and welcome all the new initiatives, particularly those aimed at encouraging more young people to come racing, as they are the future of the sport."



Complacent

IRE: Complacent on the move to Foxwood Farm

Group 1-winning sire Complacent (Authorized) has made the move to Donal White's Foxwood Farm in County Cork as Irish national hunt breeders gain a new route into his father's sireline.

The son of Authorized (Montjeu) was bred and raced by Godolphin, for whom he won the Spring Champion Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) in his native Australia. He also won a Group 2 and a brace of Group 3s, as well as finishing second in the Victoria Derby (Gr 1, 2500m).

He initially stood at Mapperley Stud in New Zealand, from where he sired five black type performers on the flat and 58 winners at a strike-rate of 62 per cent.

His roll of honour is led by the Group 2 scorer Agera and the multiple Group 3-winning pair Hi Yo Sass Bomb and Jay Bee Gee. Hi Yo Sass Bomb was also runner-up in the Livamol Classic (Gr 1, 2040m).

Complacent relocated to Haras du Mont Goubert in France for the 2023 season, meaning his oldest French-bred crop will turn two in 2026.

Francois Nicolle was among those involved in bringing Complacent to France, and the leading French trainer is now standing the horse in partnership with White.

"Complacent has all the right attributes to make a successful National Hunt stallion," Nicolle said. "He had real strength, quality and, crucially, speed as a racehorse. His sire needs no introduction to jumps breeders and we've been impressed by the youngstock he has sired in France. He certainly stamps his progeny. Given this combination, we feel he will really suit the Irish market."

White added: "He's a fine, big black horse who's 16.2 with loads of bone, a lovely step and is very correct. Authorized is doing very well on the track and in the sales ring; we all saw how well his foals sold at Goffs and Fairyhouse recently. We're conscious of the challenges commercial jumps breeders are facing at present, and have priced Complacent at a fee that gives people a real chance of turning a profit."

Complacent's fee has been set at €2,500 (approx. AU\$4,410), with a concession for fillies.

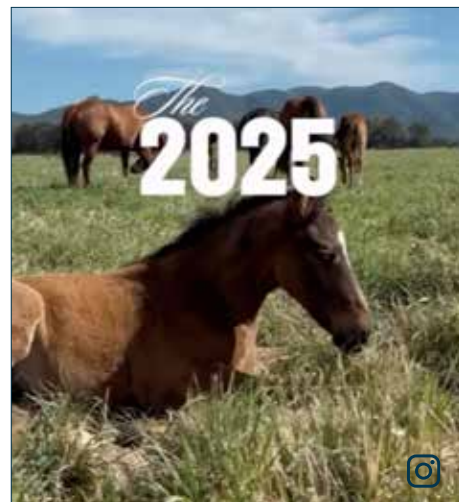
