Classy Kinnaird provides Coolmore's Home Affairs with his first stakes winner

Coolmore's first-season sire Home Affairs (I Am Invincible) supplied his first stakes winner courtesy of his talented son Kinnaird, who advertised his Karaka Million 2YO (RL, 1200m) credentials when he led home a quinella for the stallion in the Eclipse Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) at Ellerslie on New Year's Day.

Trained by Mark Walker and Sam Bergerson and sporting the tangerine colours of Te Akau,

the colt was making his first appearance since scoring over 1100 metres on his debut at Otaki in November.

Opie Bosson settled Kinnaird off the pace from his wide draw, but soon found a gap on the rail and unleashed a potent turn of foot to run down the Tony Pike-trained Harvey Wallbanger (Home Affairs) by a length.

Bosson said he had been looking for a run out wide down the home straight, but elected to keep the rail once the gap materialised.

Oaks on the horizon for Ohope Wins

An ambitious New Zealand Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) tilt now awaits the Lance O'Sullivan and Andrew Scott-trained Ohope Wins (Ocean Park) after she broke her maiden with a polished performance in the Sir Patrick Hogan Stakes (Gr 2, 2000m) at Ellerslie on New Year's Day.

The daughter of Waikato Stud's often underrated stallion Ocean Park (Thorn Park) had caught the eye when powering home late to finish second over 1600 metres at Te Rapa a fortnight ago and was one of the most discussed candidates in the lead-up to the traditional New Year's Day age-group feature. **Cont. on page 4**

"I wanted to come out, but he was a bit shy of the horse outside of me, so he gave me no choice but to come back in," Bosson said.

"Once he balanced up, he has got a good finish on him. As soon as I asked the question he really knuckled down and wanted to win, which is what you need in a colt going into a Karaka Million."

Walker was full of praise for Bosson's ride, believing it proved the difference on the colt.

"It was an Opie of old ride, that was a brilliant ride," the winning trainer said. "He is still new, he is still green, he did a lot wrong, but the experience and the class of Opie got him through."

Kinnaird was purchased out of Highview's 2025 New Zealand Bloodstock Book 1 Yearling Sale draft by Te Akau Racing principal David Ellis for NZ\$340,000 and the NZ\$1 million Karaka Million 2YO is now on the agenda for the colt.

Te Akau have won eight of the last nine editions of the Karaka Millions 2YO, with Walker winning the race with Tokyo Tycoon (Satono Aladdin) (2023) and La Dorada (Super Seth) (2025), the last in partnership with Bergerson, and he is looking forward to Kinnaird contesting the race on January 24.

"We are on the right track. It was a nice win," he said. "He will go straight in [to the Karaka Millions]."

Bosson knows what it takes to win a Karaka Millions 2YO, having ridden five Te Akau-trained juveniles to win the rich feature, and he believes Kinnaird has the ability to make it six.

"He has got a lot of upside about him," Bosson said. "He is still learning and we have still got the option of putting the blinkers on too."

Out of the winning O'Reilly (Last Tycoon) mare Orinda, Kinnaird is a half-brother to Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) winner Jon Snow (Iffraaj) as well as Listed scorer Princess

Ridden by Joe Doyle, Ohope Wins did not let her supporters down, powering home to beat Origin Of Love (Snitzel) by 2.3 lengths, with another 0.1 lengths back to Born To Be Royal (King's Legacy) in third.

The winning rider was impressed by the performance from a filly who he believes has plenty ahead of her.

"She is special as we were a long way back and had a lot of ground to make up," Doyle said.

"She is really laid back and when I started to give her a hard squeeze she came up underneath me and has won quite cosily in the end.

Apulia continues comeback with Perth Cup triumph

Apulia's (Fiorente) recent plundering of Western Australian riches continued on New Year's Day when the Lindsay Park-trained five-year-old followed up his recent win in the Ted Van Heemst Stakes (Gr 2, 2100m) with a victory in the Perth Cup (Gr 2, 2400m).

Ridden by William Pike, the entire finished strongly to beat Filthy Habits (I'm All The Talk) by a comprehensive 2.9 lengths. Forever Boy (Charm Spirit) finished a further 0.9 lengths further away in third.

In winning Thursday's Group 2, Ben, Will and JD became the first members of the Hayes family dynasty to win the time-honoured event, with their father, David, having saddled The Fuzz (Danasinga) to finish second in 2009.

Apulia capped a successful coming-of-age West Australian raid, which did not get off to the best start when he finished unplaced in the Northerly Stakes (Gr 1, 1800m) last month.

Co-trainer JD Hayes lauded the Perth Cup performance and Apulia's comeback overall.

"It was a bit of a sense of relief when we were in the first half of the field," Hayes said.

"There was a possibility we were going to be back and behind a lot of horses, not where we wanted to be.

"The way it panned out was certainly perfect, glad to see the horse be able to show what he can do."

Apulia placed second in the 2023 Victoria Derby (Gr 1, 2500m) but subsequent setbacks - a bleed and tendon injury - resulted in more than 12 months in rehabilitation.

He resumed with back-to-back wins in Melbourne last spring then travelled to Perth.

"He's been through a lot, this horse, a true testament to his character," Hayes said.

"[The] 357 days off before this preparation and he's come back and come of age, affording him the time, we're reaping the benefits now.

"This trip to Perth is going to be the making of him and (sets up a) fun autumn back home in Melbourne as well."

Hayes said Apulia could now be aimed at the Australian Cup (Gr 1, 2000m) at Flemington on March 28.

Bred by Meadowvale Pastoral Co Pty Ltd, Apulia hails from a family littered with lowercase black type, being out of Giannarelli (High Chaparral), a half-sister to the Group 2-placed winner Spot The Rock (Fastnet Rock). That pair are out of Can't Hackit (Fasliyev), who won twice and finished third in Group 2 company.

Apulia is one of 11 stakes scorers for Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) winner Fiorente (Monsun), who died in 2023.

“I just think she has Oaks written all over her as she will be majorly competitive.”

O’Sullivan shares that opinion of the filly, who is nominated for the New Zealand Classic which will be run at Ellerslie on February 21.

“Andrew and I have always believed in this filly and that was why we were lining her up today in a Group 2 as a maiden,” he said.

“Hopefully she will be running in the Oaks or the Derby, or races like that in the future.

“The best way to describe her is that she is a pet. She has a temperament where she doesn’t waiver with anything and that will hold her in good stead moving forward.

“We won’t make any plans today but come Monday morning Andrew and I will work out a programme for her.

“We had said to Joe to just ride her as you find her as with races like these you know half of the field are not going to stay as they are having their first crack at the distance.

“We were hoping he could come to the

outside and get some clear air and he summed it up nicely, it was a great ride.

“We have always thought she was a stayer from day dot and nothing has changed that opinion.”

Bred and raced by Bill Gartshore and his family under their Gartshore Bloodstock banner, Ohope Wins should have no issues

with the 2400-metre trip of the Oaks, being out of the Redoute’s Choice (Danehill) mare Choux Mania, a half-sister to the 2010-2011 Horse of the Year Jimmy Choux, who won five Group 1 races including the 2011 New Zealand Derby (Gr 1, 2400m). The dam is also a three-quarter-sister to Group 1 winner Miss Wilson (Stratum).

22 for Shalaa



Shalaa WOODSIDE PARK STUD

Woodside Park Stud sire Shalaa (Invincible Spirit) registered his 22nd individual stakes winner on Thursday when emerging sprinter King's Secret (4 g ex Confidential Queen by Shamardal) landed the Canterbury Sprint (Listed, 1200m). Trained by Joseph Pride, the half-brother to Group 1 winner and dual The Everest (Gr 1, 1200m) placegetter Private Eye (Al Maher) hit the front at the 200 metres and repelled a brave challenge from The Instructor (Russian Revolution) to score by 0.3 lengths. Barber (Exceed And Excel) finished another 1.7 lengths back in third. King's Secret took his record to six wins from 11 starts, and Pride expects he will continue to progress. "He's done a lot in these early stages of his career, but there's a lot more to come," Pride said. "In 12 months' time, who knows? He might go to the same level his brother reached, not that I'm

saying he's going to be as good as him." Bred by Goodwood Farm, King's Secret sold to his trainer and owners Proven Thoroughbreds, the same connections as Private Eye, for \$100,000 at the 2023 Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale. He is fourth foal and second stakes winner out of unplaced Shamardal (Giant's Causeway) mare Confidential Queen, herself a half-sister to the Group 3-placed King's Troop (Redoute's Choice). Shalaa stood the 2025 breeding season at an unchanged fee of \$19,800 (inc GST).

Six for Winning Rupert

Geisel Park Stud sire Winning Rupert (Written Tycoon) supplied his sixth individual stakes winner when the Simon Miller-trained Madhi Girl (4 m ex Very Angry Gal by Gingerbread Man) struck in Thursday's Summer Scorcher (Listed, 1000m) at Perth. Ridden by leading WA rider William Pike, the four-year-old mare held off the fast-finishing Jaz Session (Sessions) to score by 0.2 lengths, with Richanco (Rich Enuff) a further 0.4 lengths back in third. Bred by Mr D Beacham, Madhi Girl sold to Teleah Hulse for \$68,000 at the 2023 Magic Millions Perth Yearling Sale out of the Western Breeders Alliance draft. She is the only winner from three runners to date out of winning mare Very Angry Gal (Gingerbread Man) herself a half-sister to Listed winner Profit Street (Viscount). Winning Rupert stood the 2025 season at \$6,600 (inc GST).

Luvnwar takes La Trice Classic

Luvnwar (5 m ex Pretty Woman by Pins) added a first Group win to her CV when she took out the La Trice Classic (Gr 3, 1800m) at Ascot on New Year's Day. Ridden by Clint Johnston-Porter for trainer Michael Grantham, the five-year-old proved a length too strong for her eight rivals, beating Secret Attraction (Savabeel) into second with Admiration Express (My Admiration) another 1.2 lengths behind in third. Luvnwar was adding to her Belmont Guineas (Listed, 1600m) victory as a three-year-old.

Thanks Gorgeous breaks maiden

After finishing a narrow third in the Quezette Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) in August, the Mark and Levi Kavanagh-trained Thanks Gorgeous (Peltzer) delivered on her early promise with a dominant maiden victory at Mornington on New Year's Day. The three-year-old filly was fourth at her previous start over 1200 metres and benefited from the drop back to 1000 metres, sprinting clear under jockey Jake Noonan to score by 2.3 lengths over Grahame Begg-trained Shapenapit (Bivouac), with Heidi Dancer (Brazen Beau) a further 0.7 lengths away in third. "She's been knocking on the door and really close, and been a little

bit frustrating," Levi Kavanagh said post-race. "We dropped her back to a couple of maidens and she just didn't get a lot of luck. It was a good ride today by Jake, we dropped her back to 1000 metres today, so he had plenty of horse left." Although she has been in work for some time, connections believe the filly is now ready to step back into stronger company. "She's still won by an impressive margin - we think she's a good filly, she's got a lot more runs left in her better races," he said. "It's good for her to tick that box today...we'll see how she pulls up, and whether we go back to Metropolitan grade in another couple of weeks, we'll just have a look and see."

Horatius continues winning streak

Clinton McDonald's Horatius (Super Seth) made a winning start to Benchmark grade racing at Mornington on New Year's Day, following a unique lead-up which included a priest's blessing. The gelding broke his maiden from midfield at Cranbourne at his previous start, but adopted very different tactics stepping up to the mile, with Ben Melham sending him straight to the front and setting a strong tempo throughout. Running his rivals into the ground, Horatius proved too strong at every stage, continuing on powerfully to score by three lengths over Triple Time (Brazen Beau), with Convo (Dundeel) another 0.3 lengths back in third. As it emerged post-race, owner Dennis Alysandratos - whose colours are also carried by promising three-year-olds Rosberg (Deep Field) and Miss Ole (Ole Kirk) - had recently arranged for his horses to be blessed at McDonald's Cranbourne stable. "I was pretty confident coming here today - Dennis and his family thought I needed a blessing, so we got Father Nick down and blessed all Dennis' horses," McDonald told Racing.com. "It's obviously paid dividends today. I'm just rapt for everybody involved in the horse and the

staff, who do a great job at home. I was more confident once I got to the races: I could see the horse's behaviour, and how he'd really settled. Good ride by Benny, he jumped, put himself in the race, and he was too good. I think he can keep improving, I don't know where the ceiling is."

I Am Invincible filly ready to go at Randwick

Thyme To Go (I Am Invincible) will make her race debut in Saturday's \$160,000 contest over 1000 metres at Randwick, having already earned a reputation as the biggest two-year-old in the Archibald stable. A \$260,000 purchase from the Inglis Premier Yearling Sale, Thyme To Go has progressed well enough to line up on the opening Saturday of the new year, despite her imposing frame. "She's very big - the biggest two-year-old in the stable - she's quite mature looking," Annabel Archibald told SENTrack. "I think she's going to be better over a little bit further, but I think this is a good starting point. She's got a massive stride, so hopefully she can break well and have plenty of room." Thyme To Go is one of six debutants in the field, which includes high-priced yearlings Excelluna (Exceed And Excel) (\$500,000) and Sweet Intent (Written Tycoon) (\$475,000). The most expensive runner is \$750,000 Magic Millions buy Knightsbridge (Farnan), who has already been tested at Group level, finishing fifth in the Breeders Plate (Gr 3, 1000m). Out of the More Than Ready (Southern Halo) mare Joy At Last, Thyme To Go finished sixth in her first trial on December 8 before producing a sharp performance at her most recent hit-out, beating Knightsbridge by a half-length. "The horse that was second there in the trial, Knightsbridge, is in the field as well," Archibald said. "She's obviously a first starter and being a two-year-old it's always a little bit of an unknown, but she is a lovely filly." Thyme To Go will jump from barrier one with Zac Lloyd aboard.

McEvoy's hoping Moana Spirit rises to occasion

Calvin McEvoy concedes Saturday's \$150,000 Geelong Diamond (1100m) presents a far sterner test than Moana Spirit's (Tagaloo) debut, but that is precisely what appeals as the filly steps up in class. Training in partnership with his father Tony, McEvoy is keen to assess where the daughter of Tagaloo (Lord Kanaloo) sits in a race that has quickly established itself as a producer of elite juveniles. Moana Spirit lines up as one of four runners in the 1100-metre contest to boast a perfect one-from-one record, with the Yulong-bred and owned filly set to be tested against deeper opposition. "It's the time of the year that a lot of the horses that missed the spring features are up and going and I think she's got a bright future, so I'm looking forward to seeing her in this race," McEvoy said. The McEvoy's elected to target the Geelong Diamond for following Moana Spirit's two-length debut victory at Morphettville on December 6, a three-horse race in which \$1.26 favourite Inhabit (Stay Inside) failed to finish after pulling up with an issue. Since then, Moana Spirit has further enhanced her credentials with an impressive 800-metre Flemington jump-out. "She went to Adelaide as a raw filly and won and she's taken a lot of improvement from that experience," McEvoy said. "She had a very nice trial in between and I think she's in with a nice chance." Luke Currie takes over from Rochelle Milnes at Geelong, where the filly is a well-supported second favourite behind the Ciaran Maher-trained Ghana's Akan (Street Boss).

Holymanz hones in on Coastal hat-trick

Ciaran Maher-trained gelding Holymanz (Almanzor) will look to extend his stranglehold on the Coastal Classic (1700m) when he lines up in Saturday's edition at Geelong. Winner of the only two runnings of the 1700-metre contest famous for its giant surfboard trophy, the Cambridge Stud-owned six-year-old once again headlines the feature event of Geelong's Saturday meeting and Maher's assistant trainer Jack Turnbull believes he is going as well as ever. Last year's success under 60 kilograms marked Holymanz's first win since claiming the inaugural Coastal Classic, but he arrives this time off a last-start victory, dead-heating with Geelong rival Precious Charm (Per Incanto) in the Werribee Cup (1600m) on December 7. "The horse is extremely well," Turnbull said. "He's probably arguably in better form, he's got to carry the weight, but I wouldn't say it's as strong as a race as he found last year. Hopefully we can package up and send back to New Zealand a third surfboard. Once we picked up the second board, we were always keen to come back for the third." Holymanz rises half a kilogram for last year's win and heads betting from former stablemate St Lawrence (Redwood), now trained by Gavin Bedggood, and the Liam Howley-trained Opening Address (So You Think). Michael Dee, who rode Holymanz to victory in the inaugural Coastal Classic, resumes the partnership on Saturday. The pair will jump from barrier six in the field of ten.

Sylph handed Sunlight slot

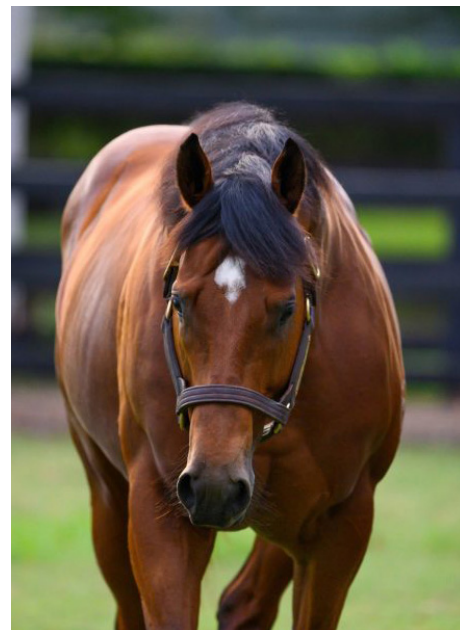
Yarraman-bred and raced filly Sylph (I Am Invincible) will don the green and white silks of Yulong when she contests the \$3 million Magic Millions Sunlight (1100m) on Saturday, January 10. The half-sister to Group 1 winner Booker (Written Tycoon) will race under different colours as part of a slot arrangement finalised on the eve of the 2026 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale, swapping her familiar yellow and black silks for the feature sprint. Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m)-winning jockey Jamie Melham has been engaged for the ride. By I Am Invincible and out of Group 1-producing Flying Spur (Danehill) mare Noondie, Sylph heads into the Sunlight in strong form, having been stakes-placed at her past two starts in Queensland, both narrow defeats, and now boasts four placings from six starts, including two black-type performances in December. Trainer Michael Freedman is pleased with the filly's progress heading into the race. "She's in great order and will have a gallop on Tuesday morning," he said. "We expect her to be very competitive." Yarraman's Harry Mitchell welcomed the partnership with Yulong, highlighting the filly's pedigree and race record. "We're delighted to partner with Yulong. She's a dual Stakes-placed Vinnie filly bred by Yarraman and raced in partnership, and it's exciting to see her get this opportunity." Sylph's recent black-type form has also delivered a timely pedigree boost for her brother, who will be offered by Yarraman Park Stud as **Lot 617** at the Magic Millions on Thursday, January 15.

First for Home Affairs

Coolmore's first-season sire Home Affairs (I Am Invincible) got 2026 off to the best possible start when his son Kinnaird (2 c ex Orinda by O'Reilly) supplied the stallion with his first individual stakes winner courtesy of a stylish win in Thursday's Eclipse Stakes (Gr 2, 12000m)

at Ellerslie, leading home a quinella for the stallion in the process. Kinnaird was purchased out of Highview's 2025 New Zealand Bloodstock Book 1 Yearling Sale draft by Te Akau Racing principal David Ellis for NZ\$340,000 and the NZ\$1 million Karaka Million 2YO (RL, 1200m) is now on the agenda for the colt. Out of the winning O'Reilly (Last Tycoon) mare Orinda, Kinnaird is a half-brother to Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) winner Jon Snow (Ifraaj) as well as Listed scorer Princess Rhaenys (Ifraaj). Orinda is a half-sister to dual Group 3 winner Mr Ubiquitous (Tale Of The Cat). Kinnaird is one of three winners for Home Affairs, who has just completed covering his fourth season at Coolmore Stud in the Hunter Valley. The son of I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit) covered 205 mares at a fee of \$82,500 (inc GST). The Coolmore Stud Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner and Black Caviar Lightning Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m) supplied the top lot at last year's Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale when Mitsu Nakauchida purchased a filly by the stallion out of Sunlight for \$3.2 million, and the stallion has 46 yearlings entered at this year's edition which gets under way on January 13.

Australia's reigning champion sire Zoustar (Northern Meteor) added a 74th individual stakes winner to his glowing record when Queen Zou (5 m ex Lady Oracle by Medaglia D'Oro) captured Thursday's Rich Hill Mile (Gr 2, 1600m) at Ellerslie. The five-year-old mare produced a powerful closing burst, charging home from well back to score by a decisive 0.3 lengths over Son Of Sun (Tavistock) in the Group 2 feature. Checkmate (Mongolian Khan) finished another 0.4 lengths further adrift in third. Bred by Phoenix Thoroughbred, Queen Zou was a \$650,000 Inglis Easter Yearling purchase in 2022 for her trainer Stephen Marsh out of the Vinery Stud draft. She is the only winner out of Medaglia D'Oro (El Prado) mare Lady Oracle, herself a half-sister to Listed winner Varda (Lonhro) with the

pair both out of Group 3 winner Wild Queen (Loup Sauvage).

Thorndon Mile plan for Queen Zou

Stephen Marsh is set to press on toward another major mile target with Queen Zou, following the mare's Rich Hill Mile victory at Ellerslie on New Year's Day. With the Ellerslie assignment ticked off, Marsh confirmed the Thorndon Mile (Gr 2, 1600m) at Trentham on January 17 is the next major objective. Marsh had anticipated a strong tempo in the Rich Hill Mile, believing it would suit Queen Zou's customary closing style, and admitted he was enjoying what he saw as the race unfolded. "This is a race we wanted to win with her and I just loved how they put the pressure on so far out as she was just stalking," he said. "She looked awesome beforehand and it is very exciting and rewarding for everyone." Rider Matt Cartwright believes the mare is capable of reaching even higher levels as her campaign progresses. "She is such a beautiful, honest mare and one who is so deserving of a win like this," he said. "She put the writing on the wall last start [when runner-up in the Cal Isuzu Stakes at Te Rapa]. We enjoyed a beautiful run, got out at the right time and she just attacked the line. She means a lot to me and I was quite excited after the line. I feel like she is up to Group 1 quality and can take that next step."

25 for Ocean Park

In winning Thursday's Sir Patrick Hogan Stakes (Gr 2, 2000m) at Ellerslie, the Lance O'Sullivan and Andrew Scott-trained Ohope Wins (3 f ex Choux Mania by Redoute's Choice) became the 25th individual stakes winner for Waikato Stud-based sire Ocean Park (Thorn Park). Bred and raced by Bill Gartshore and his family under their Gartshore Bloodstock banner, Ohope Wins is out of the Redoute's Choice (Danehill) mare Choux Mania, a half-sister to the 2010-2011 Horse of the Year Jimmy Choux, who won five Group 1 races including the 2011 New Zealand Derby (Gr 1, 2400m). The dam is also a three-quarter-sister to Group 1 winner Miss Wilson (Stratum). The New Zealand Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) is now the likely target for Ohope Wins.

Two for Puccini

Puccini (Encosta De Lago) registered his second individual stakes winner when Peter and the Shaun McKay-trained Santa Catalina (5 m ex Tarantella by O'Reilly) landed Thursday's Queen Elizabeth II Cup (Gr 3, 2400m) at Ellerslie. The Matamata-trained mare was bred by Mapperley Stud principal Simms Davison out of O'Reilly mare Tarantella, herself out of a half-sister to 1992 New Zealand 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Hulastrake (Straight Strike). Santa Catalina is raced by Davison in partnership with Peter and Kim McKay.

Jones grabs first Group victory in New Zealand

Angela Jones achieved a career milestone at Ellerslie on New Year's Day, recording her first Group victory in New Zealand aboard Santa Catalina in the Queen Elizabeth II Cup. The Queensland premiership-winning rider had crossed the Tasman to partner Smart Love (Savabeel) for Wexford Stables in the Rich Hill Mile, but while that assignment did not yield a result, Jones made her mark with a composed staying ride for Matamata trainers Peter McKay and Shaun McKay. Backing

up a week after finishing fifth in the Stayers' Championship Final (2400m), Santa Catalina scored a 0.8-length victory over Trust In You (Sweynesse). "I thought I didn't give her the best of rides in the early stages," Jones said. "She jumped well and they said if she jumps well they wanted her to be thereabouts. We didn't really have enough speed to get us out of trouble. I was pretty happy when I had cover at least, and she settled beautifully. She gets this trip well because you put her in a spot and she settles so well. I would never say she felt like the winner, but she was there when I needed her. She is very tough." The McKay stable now have renewed confidence to extend the mare's campaign toward longer targets later in the summer. "We knew she pulled up really well [from Ellerslie on Boxing Day] so we didn't worry about the back-up and it was a good win," Shaun McKay said. "Winning any race at Ellerslie is superb and winning a Group race is even better. We would love to aim for a Wellington Cup and see how she goes. She is a good stayer in the making. I

would say she will have another start [before the Wellington Cup] but we will just see how she pulls up and go from there."

Two for Dracarys

Oakwood Farm's Dracarys (Snitzel) sired his second individual stakes winner on Thursday when the David Hayes-trained Storm Rider (5 g ex Zeffiretta by Husson) landed The Chinese Club Challenge Cup (Gr 3, 1400m) at Sha Tin. Ridden by Karis Teetan, the gelding defeated Dancing Code (Panzer Division) by a short neck, while Patch Of Thea (Zoustar) was just a neck further away in third. Bred by Ms S Wood, Storm Rider was an \$80,000 purchase for Merrick Staunton out of Oakwood Farm's 2022 Magic Millions Gold Coast March Yearling Sale draft. He is the fourth foal and one of two winners out of Husson (Hussonet) mare Zeffiretta, herself a close relation to the Group 1-placed winner Fist Of Fury (Hussonet).

Hayes and Teetan combine with Storm Rider to land New Year's Day Group 3 feature

Karis Teetan extended a deepening affinity with the Chinese Club Challenge Cup Handicap (Gr 3, 1400m) at Sha Tin on New Year's Day when the Mauritian pocketed his fourth victory in the race by piloting David Hayes-trained Storm Rider (Dracarys) to a thrilling victory.

Teetan had previously triumphed in the Chinese Club Challenge Cup on Fifty Fifty (Thorn Park) (2018), Champion's Way (Hinchinbrook) (2021) and Patch Of Theta (Zoustar) (2025), while Hayes' most recent success in the race was with Schubert (Salieri) in 2000.

Carrying only 115lb, Storm Rider drove relentlessly under Teetan's riding to overhaul Dancing Code (Panzer Division) in the last few strides to triumph by a short head in 1m 20.62s, with Patch Of Theta (Zoustar) a neck further away in third.

Rated 86 before Thursday's victory, Storm Rider has the ability to reach triple figures in the standings, according to Hayes.

"I just think he's a horse that has got the potential to go above 100 and he was beautifully rated for his ability. My only concern was the barrier [nine], but Karis rode such a great race, it took the barrier out of that. Once he got that nice run, he was always going to be hard to beat with that light weight," Hayes said.

Teetan said: "It's a good start to the New Year. His trial last week was a really good trial. Last start, he just pulled too hard and he still ran home. The horse was coming to the races today with good form and David was very bullish that the horse could run well today.

"He said to me 'Don't take this horse back today, go forward and make our own luck' so full credit to David and his team. The horse was very well."

Harry Bentley is confident Frankie Lor-trained Smart Golf (Needs Further) will

progress through the grades after the gelding's emphatic win in the first section of the Class 4 Hillwood Handicap (1200m).

"He's been trialling extremely well and I got on him for one trial and he led and gave me a really good feel, so I was coming into this race with a level of confidence," Bentley said. "He was able to overcome a wide draw [11] with a lot of natural speed, travelled along great and when I asked the question, he duly delivered.

"So, there should be more to come from him. He's a nice type who should climb the ranks."

Mark Newnham reclaimed the lead in the 2025/26 trainers' championship when four-year-old Infinite Resolve (Snitzel) surged to victory in the first section of the Class 3 Cha Kwo Ling Handicap (1200m) under Hugh Bowman.

Earning a PP Bonus of HK\$1.5 million, the Snitzel (Redoute's Choice) gelding - who

formerly raced as Deconstruction when trained in Australia by Ciaran Maher - gave Newnham his 27th winner for the season and, with more second placings than Caspar Fownes [also 27 wins], Newnham has wrestled back the lead.

Danny Shum (25) and Hayes (23) are also within in close reach of the lead after 33 of the season's 88 scheduled meetings.

Size climbed into the top ten in the trainers' championship when Endued (Deep Field) staved off late challenges to land the Class 4 Lei Muk Shue Handicap (1600m) under Maxime Guyon.

Bidding for a record-extending 14th trainers' championship, Size said: "It's very important in this environment to start the New Year in a positive way. I don't think they [other trainers] are too worried about me yet but I've just got to keep chipping away."

Tony Cruz and Angus Chung shared the honour of delivering the first winner of the New Year when Iron Legion (Invincible Army) landed the Class 5 Tsung Pak Long Handicap (1600m) in the first of a string of blanket finishes.

The gelding prevailed by a short head from Harry's Hero (Hawkbill) with the same margin to Draco (Deep Field).

A similar scenario played out in the second section of the Class 4 Hillwood Handicap (1200m) when trainer Chris So and James Orman combined with Joy Capital (Vespa), who posted a short head margin over Sea Sapphire (Husson) with Bigtime Generation (Swiss Ace) in third.

Riding High (Exceed And Excel) prevailed at his 18th start for Douglas Whyte, dominating the Class 5 Pine Tree Hill Handicap (1200m) from the front under a clever ride from Zac Purton, who exploited barrier one to fullest to control the race.

Whyte sealed a double when Six Pack (Rubick) earned a PP Bonus of HK\$1.5 million with success in the Class 3 Chuk Yuen Handicap (1400m) under Luke Ferraris.

Yiu Cheung Victory (Shooting To Win) defied all with a tough staying display to clinch the Class 4 Mui Wo Handicap (2000m) for Dennis Yip to provide Alexis Badel with his first winner since November 30 before John Size and Brenton Avdulla triumphed with Raging Rapids (Zoustar) in the Class 4 Lai Chi Chong Handicap (1400m).

Ricky Yiu's Rising Force (Deep Field) landed a significant plunge under Richard Kingscote to snare the second section of the Class 3 Cha Kwo Ling Handicap (1200m) after jumping from barrier 14 and racing outside the leader before winning stylishly.

Backed from double figures into 3.3 second favourite behind Crossborderpegasus (Rich Enuff), Rising Force was resuming after

a ligament injury.

"He had been running well on the dirt, so I was disappointed with the draw in stall 14, but I knew the horse drawn in 13 [Matters Most] was a fast one too so we just followed him into the first bend and it worked out well," Yiu said.

"The last two trials he did were quite promising and with the light weight that he had today, I believed he would run well despite the wide draw. He's only just turned four and it was first run of the season, so I think we have a lot of improvement in him. He's fast and versatile too."

Hong Kong racing continues at Sha Tin on Sunday with the Bauhinia Sprint Trophy Handicap (Gr 3, 1000m).

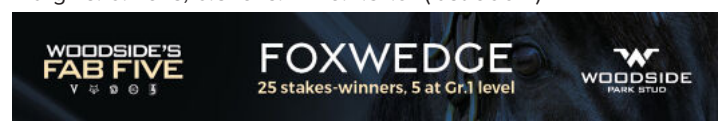
