# Ninja strikes Guineas blow with Vo Rogue rout

Ninja spearheaded a standout afternoon for second-season sire Farnan (Not A Single Doubt) with a devastating performance at Eagle Farm on Saturday, making sure the stallion's influence was felt on both sides of the border.

The Michael Freedman-trained Ninja delivered one of the most commanding performances of the Queensland summer when charging home to claim the Vo Rogue Plate (Gr 3, 1300m), cementing his status as the clear favourite for the \$3 million Magic Millions 3YO Guineas (RL, 1400m) at the Gold Coast on January 17.

The three-year-old was the second winner on the afternoon for Kia Ora's upwardly mobile Slipper (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Farnan, with another of the stallion's sons, exciting juvenile Knightsbridge, having emerged as a genuine contender for the Magic Millions 2YO Classic (RL, 1200m) after getting off the mark at Randwick.

In a race that unfolded far from script, the Ninja overcame a slow start and a position well off the speed to overwhelm his rivals with a sustained burst that turned the contest into a procession. Swinging wide around the field approaching the home turn, the gelding circled them and powered through the middle of the straight to score by 4.8 **Continued on page 2**

## Warwoven firms as Magic Millions favourite

Warwoven (Sword Of State) continued his seamless rise through the juvenile ranks at Eagle Farm on Saturday, reinforcing his position at the head of Magic Millions 2YO Classic markets with a polished victory in the QTIS Two-Year-Old Handicap over 1200 metres.

The Bjorn Baker-trained colt was sent out the \$1.65 favourite and duly made light work of his rivals, cruising clear from an off-pace ride by Rachel King to score by three and a half lengths over Lumbini (Russian Revolution) and Leaves Of Lorien (Cool Aza Beel), with King able to ease him down late. **Continued on page 4**

**Continued from page 1** lengths under Tommy Berry – a margin that barely captured the authority of the performance.

Pierata (Pierro) filly Smexy came home in second, with So You Think (High Chaparral) filly Adorable Thought another 0.6 lengths back in third.

Saturday was Ninja's third win from five starts following a close third behind Grafterburners (Graff) in the Pierata Plate (1200m) at Doomben on December 6. That run came after a spring spell, with the gelding having previously shown promise through the winter, placing on debut before winning twice in his first three starts. His earnings now exceed \$325,000.

Despite jumping awkwardly and losing ground at the start, Berry never panicked, allowing Ninja time to find his rhythm as a solid tempo unfolded in front.

"You always have to have Plan B but that wasn't even a Plan B for me," Berry said.

"He was so well behaved today and he stood in the gates beautifully quiet but when the starter called 'all clear', usually the gates open not long after.

"I gave him a bit of a squeeze to jump but there was a hold-up so he hit the front of the gates.

"He took a step back and lunged out. We were hoping for an easy run today with two weeks' time in mind and he really only sprinted 500 metres."

Berry was able to ease the gelding down late, an ominous sign given the step up to 1400 metres now awaits at the Gold Coast. The winning rider was quick to acknowledge the groundwork laid by Ninja's regular rider Andrew Adkins, who partnered him in all of his previous starts.

"Andrew Adkins deserves all the credit, today is the first time I've ridden the horse, he's done all the work and I'm lucky to reap the reward," he said.

The market reacted swiftly, with bookmakers slashing Ninja's Magic Millions Guineas quote from \$4 into \$2 within minutes.

A \$380,000 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale purchase from Segenhoe Stud, Ninja was bred by Fairway Thoroughbreds and is raced by a broad ownership group which

includes MyRacehorse, his trainer and Damon Gabbedy's Belmont Bloodstock Agency.

He is the best of three winners from four foals to race out of Impulsive (So You Think), a metro-winning half-sister to South African Grade 1 winner Laisserfaire (Danehill) as well as four other stakes winners, including the Group 1-placed pair Foreplay (Danehill) and Time Thief (Redoute's Choice).

Ninja became the fourth stakes winner from Farnan's first crop, joining stakes-winning juveniles King Of Pop, North England and Recuperato.

## Knightsbridge enhances Farnan's Carnival momentum

Farnan's two-year-old colt Knightsbridge emerged as a standout from his sire's second crop of runners when he made a winning debut at Randwick on Saturday, strengthening the hand of co-trainers Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott ahead of the \$3 million Magic Millions 2YO Classic.

The \$750,000 Magic Millions purchase took out the Kia Ora Yearlings @ MMGC Plate (1000m), overpowering early leader Thyme To Go (I Am Invincible) to score by a length, with the Bjorn Baker-trained Profitabelle (Profiteer) a further half-length away in third.

After two trials, Knightsbridge, who is raced by the James Harron Colt Partnership and Tony

Fung, showed professionalism beyond his experience, settling into the run before finding strongly through the line, a performance that suggested the colt will relish the step up to 1200 metres on the Gold Coast.

"He got to both of his trials quite quickly this preparation and he still has good improvement in his fitness coming into today and that is good stepping up to a Magic Millions," said Bott, who, alongside Waterhouse, trained Farnan throughout his illustrious career.

Jockey Adam Hyeronimus was similarly bullish post-race, saying: "He's got a beautiful attitude and nothing worries him."

"I was quite concerned pre-race with Final Gift and I stressed to the owners that I didn't want to be following him but that horse probably won us the race but pressuring the leader. We were always going to be strong late and he was."

Knightsbridge is now rated a \$15 chance for the Magic Millions 2YO Classic on January 17.

A half-brother to stakes winners Semana (Winning Rupert) and Gala Queen (Deep Field), Knightsbridge fourth winner from four to race out of Nicconi (Bianconi) mare Festivity, herself a half-sister to the Group 2-placed Listed winner Merriest (Denman).

Farnan covered 141 mares at a fee of \$77,000 (inc GST) last season and he will be represented by 24 yearlings at the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale which gets underway on January 13.

## Warwoven firms as Magic Millions favourite

Warwoven (Sword Of State) continued his seamless rise through the juvenile ranks at Eagle Farm on Saturday, reinforcing his position at the head of Magic Millions 2YO Classic markets with a polished victory in the QTIS Two-Year-Old Handicap over 1200 metres.

The Bjorn Baker-trained colt was sent out the \$1.65 favourite and duly made light work of his rivals, cruising clear from an off-pace ride by Rachel King to score by three and a half lengths over Lumbini (Russian Revolution) and Leaves Of Lorien (Cool Aza Beel), with King able to ease him down late.

The son of Cambridge Stud's first-season sire Sword Of State (Snitzel) further entrenched himself as a leading contender for the \$3 million Magic Millions 2YO Classic at the Gold Coast on January 17, for which he is now rated a \$2.20 chance (from \$3).

For Baker, the result was less about the margin and more about the colt's composure as he builds toward the Gold Coast feature.

"It was more about having a hit out for two weeks' time in the Magic Millions," said Baker.

"The one thing he did today which I was very happy with was that he paraded beautifully and he was lovely and relaxed. If you didn't like him pre-race, after his parade you would have had to."

Already a winner on debut at Randwick over 1000 metres on December 20, Warwoven has quickly assumed the role of stable standard-bearer following the highly regarded Magic Millions Wyong 2YO Classic (RL, 1100m) winner Paradoxium's (Extreme Choice) withdrawal from the Magic Millions 2YO Classic due to illness.

Baker, who has previously won the lucrative Gold Coast feature with Unencumbered (Testa Rossa) and O' Ole (Ole Kirk), believes temperament is a key ingredient in navigating the pressures of the Magic Millions Carnival.

"I've been lucky enough to win the Magic Millions twice before and those horses have had great attitudes," Baker added.

"He's definitely got that and it carries you far in high pressure races at high pressure times of the year. We just have to try and hold him together for another two weeks."

Rachel King, who has partnered Warwoven in both race-day victories as well as his first trial, was equally emphatic in her assessment of the colt.

"He's just a superstar horse," she said. "He's been like that since day one - his first start he was the same when he executed perfectly."

"So far we haven't found anything that bothers him and I don't think anything will. He's just got that good horse attitude and the class to go with it. He had to stand in the gates for a long time today which wasn't good for him - not because he's naughty or anything but he just goes to sleep."

"He's so quiet. I had to get him to move his feet a touch before the gates opened. All these experiences are helping him and he's getting better every start. Today he didn't get out of second gear."

Warwoven now boasts earnings of \$143,500 and heads north with momentum firmly on his side.

A \$380,000 Magic Millions purchase from the Kia Ora Stud draft, Warwoven runs in the colours of Ridgmont and a strong ownership group, with Kia Ora also retaining an interest. Bred by Kia Ora, he is the first foal out of Group 2 winner Needle And Thread (Makfi), who has since produced a colt and a filly by the farm's leading second-season sire Farnan. That colt will be offered by Blue Gum Farm (as agent)

as **Lot 671** at the Inglis Premier Yearling Sale which begins its three-day run at Oaklands in Melbourne on March 1.

The result continued a strong start for Sword Of State, already the sire of Australian stakes winner Torture, with further depth among his first crop emerging on both sides of the Tasman as his filly State The Obvious also broke her maiden at her second career start at Te Aroha on Saturday.

The son of Snitzel (Redoute's Choice) stood the 2025 season at an increased fee of NZ\$20,000 (plus GST).

## Lassified streaks to Wellesley Stakes success

Talented filly Lassified (Stay Inside) underlined her stakes credentials with a dominant front-running display to claim Saturday's Wellesley Stakes (Listed, 1100m), first black-type race run at Trentham this season in

Trained by Andrew Forsman, the daughter of Golden Slipper (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Stay Inside (Extreme Choice) has shown toughness and versatility throughout her short career, with her trainer not afraid to travel in search of the right opportunities.

After scoring on debut at Tauherenikau, Lassified returned to Trentham last month for the Wakefield Challenge Stakes (Gr 2,

**Continued from page 4** 1100m), where she performed creditably in fourth behind unbeaten filly Lara Antipova (Russian Revolution).

Ridden by Bruno Queiroz for the first time on Saturday, the filly let down stylishly at the 300 metres and kicked clear, and despite the brave efforts of Sweetest Thing (Hello Youmzain) late, she proved too strong, scoring by a half-length at the line. Out Of The Blue (Tivaci) finished a further length behind in third.

A \$110,000 purchase from the draft of Glenbeigh Farm by her trainer and Andrew Williams Bloodstock at the 2025 Inglis Classic Yearling Sale, Lassified races in Terry Henderson's OTI Racing silks.

She had been a \$70,000 weanling purchase from the draft of Twin Hills Stud by Glenbeigh Farm at the 2024 Inglis Great Southern Sale.

While Lassified is not eligible for the Karaka Millions, Henderson said a trip to Sydney is on the cards, with the filly set to contest the \$2 million Inglis Millennium (RL, 1100m) on February 7.

"It's fantastic for all of the owners in this filly, they're getting an enormous thrill," Henderson said.

"We aren't known for buying these short-course horses, but the Inglis Race Series is such an incredible incentive to get new owners involved in racing, especially the ladies ownership groups with the Pink Bonus.

"She's now had the three starts in New Zealand for two wins, so the plan is to bring her over to Australia for a possible tilt at the \$2 million Inglis Millennium. The prize-money in the Inglis Race Series is such a big carrot in

attracting owners to buy shares in racehorses."

Stable representative Joe Walker was full of praise for the filly's attitude and professionalism following the win.

"She is so professional, tough and has a great attitude," Walker said.

"It's a massive thrill for everyone involved, including OTI and our ladies syndicate, and with a couple of owners on-course today it is very special.

"She has had a couple of big trips to Tauherenikau and twice here. We thought she was very game last time where it didn't work out for her, but she was as tough as.

"The key was getting her down to the fence today and leading, where she was always going to take some catching.

"It was a case of getting her here in one


piece and getting the result, which now opens up a lot of options for her."

The result saw Lassified become the second individual stakes winner for Newgate Farm's first-season sire Stay Inside, who stood for a fee of \$66,000 (inc GST) in 2025, up from \$55,000 in 2024.

She is out of the Listed-winning Nicconi (Bianconi) mare Exclusive Lass, who is also the dam of the Group 2-placed winner Boyfriend (Snitzel) and fellow winners Cape Breton (Vancouver) and Midwest Princess (King's Legacy).


A Russian Revolution (Snitzel) half-brother to Lassified will be offered as **Lot 795** at the 2026 Inglis Classic Yearling Sale on account of Sledmere Stud.

Stay Inside will be represented by 36 yearlings at the upcoming Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale.

#### Four for Farnan

Kia Ora's Golden Slipper (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Farnan (Not A Single Doubt) scored his fourth individual stakes winner when the Michael Freedman-trained Ninja (3 g ex Impulsive by So You Think) produced an ultra impressive performance in Saturday's Vo Rogue Plate (Gr 3, 1300m) at Eagle Farm. Ninja was a \$380,000 pick up by his trainer, MyRacehorse, Gandarvi and Damon Gabbedy's Belmont Bloodstock at the 2024 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling from the Segenhoe Stud draft, who were offering the youngster on behalf of his breeder, John Camilleri's Fairway Thoroughbreds. He is out of Impulsive, a three-time scorer by So You Think (High Chaparral) who has produced two other winners. Impulsive is a daughter of

Group 3 scorer Procrastinate (Jade Hunter), making her a half-sister to South African Grade 1 winner Laisserfaire (Danehill), Group 3 scorer A Time For Julia (Redoute's Choice) as well as stakes-winning trio Time Thief (Redoute's Choice), Foreplay (Danehill) and Personify (Galileo), the dam of VRC Oaks (Gr 1, 2500m) winner Personal (Fastnet Rock). Farnan covered 141 mares at a fee of \$77,000 (inc GST) last season and he will be represented by 24 yearlings at the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale which gets underway on January 13.

#### 100 for Lonhro

Darley's late Champion sire Lonhro (Octagonal) notched up his 100th individual stakes winner on Saturday when Lonhro's Queen (5 m ex Queen Of The Hill, by Danehill) took out the Nudgee Stakes (Listed, 1200m) at Eagle Farm. Trained by Chris and Corey Munce and ridden by Rachel King, who enjoyed a double on the day, the mare defeated Midnight In Tokyo (Kobayashi) by 0.9 lengths, with Sunset Dreaming (Impending) a further 1.6 lengths behind in third. Bred and raced by Gooree Stud, the mare is the eighth foal and first stakes winner out of dual Group 3 winner Queen Of The Hill (Danehill), also the dam of stakes placegetter Explosive Mischief (More

Than Ready). Queen Of The Hill herself is a half-sister to Group 1-winning sire Northern Meteor (Encosta De Lago) and Listed scorer Rabbuka (Giant's Causeway). Lonhro died in 2024.

#### No Magic Millions aim for paddock-bound Lonhro's Queen

In winning Saturday's Nudgee Stakes, Lonhro's Queen won a golden ticket into the \$1 million Magic Millions Fillies & Mares (1300m) on the Gold Coast in a fortnight, but co-trainer Chris Munce said that after a busy campaign the mare will now head to the paddock instead. She won first-up at Eagle Farm in early November and was then second behind Midnight In Tokyo in the Tattersall's Classic (Listed, 1200m) at Doomben later that month. "It's all been about bringing this mare up to stakes grade," he said. "So it's job done and she'll have a rest now and we'll see where we go after that in the winter. She really is a lovely mare to do anything with. She's a pleasure to have around and she's thriving."

on Saturday and she will now head for a break before embarking on an ambitious preparation geared towards the Queensland Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m). Nightline was a long-odds winner of the City to Surf 3YO (1600m) at Doomben two starts ago before enduring a torrid run when 12th in the Grand Prix Stakes (Gr 3, 1800m). The filly proved that performance was a blip, comfortably defeating Mr Worthington (Worthy Cause) by 1.3 lengths with Tambeloa (Tagaloe) another 1.5 lengths away in third. The victory delivered the Sears with back-to-back wins in the 2100-metre contest, with the father-daughter training combination responsible for last year's winner Beau Dazzler (Ardrossan), who returned to place in the Queensland Guineas (Gr 2, 1600m) on his next appearance. "It's great to see her do that. We've got a very high opinion of her," Maddy Sears said. "When she won at big odds, it wasn't a fluke, and we thought she would win very well again today. She's a bit colt-like in her demeanour, her work, everything about her. She doesn't look like a filly, she's a brute. She's booked on a truck on Monday to go straight to the paddock, and then we'll get ready for the Oaks. She's very classy and they would want to look out for her." Sears Racing purchased Nightline out of Book 2 of the Karaka from the draft of Westbury Stud for NZ\$75,000 in conjunction with Paul Moroney Bloodstock and Catheryne Bruggeman.

## 31 for Too Darn Hot

Darley shuttler Too Darn Hot (Dubawi) supplied his 31st individual stakes winner and 14th in Australia when the Jenni The Fox (4 m ex Miss Foxwood by Fastnet Rock) provided Lucy Yeomans with her first stakes race win in Saturday's Black Pearl Stakes (Listed, 1200m) at Geelong. The mare was bought by her owner Tony Ottobre's Cape Schanck Stud for \$380,000 from Segenhoe Stud's Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale draft in 2023 and she is the sixth winner from six to race out of the Group 3-placed Fastnet Rock (Danehill) mare Miss

## Yeomans celebrates first stakes win

With her victory in Geelong's Black Pearl Stakes on Saturday, Jenni The Fox provided trainer Lucy Yeomans with her first stakes winner and she was understandably delighted with the result.

The daughter of Too Darn Hot defeated Hearcomesthestar (Zoustar) by 1.8 lengths with Naifah (I Am Invincible) filling the final spot on the podium a further 0.2 lengths away.

The win came after a timely phone call from owner Tony Ottobre, who believed the mare was ready to return to work following a short break after finishing 12th in The Supernova (1400m) in mid-December. Yeomans said Ottobre's judgement was spot-on.

"That's the great thing about training for Tony, he knows these horses so well. I would think I know her better than anyone, but I think Tony might rival me for that," Yeomans told Racing.com.

After training in partnership with Lloyd Kennewell, Yeomans launched her solo career at the start of the season and has now prepared four winners - all owned by Ottobre - from just 17 runners.

"I can't believe it. There are too many people to thank. Obviously, Tony, Elise, who's my right-hand girl, just turned this horse out in immaculate condition today," Yeomans said.

Yeomans admitted the win was the result of meticulous preparation and a little self-imposed pressure.

"I've been riding all my own track work, and I've been absolutely cooking myself overthinking everything, but I galloped this horse on Tuesday and she absolutely flew.

"I actually had my partner Blake [Shinn] there clocking me and the tracker just said her recovery was better than ever," she said.

The mare's victory opens the door to a possible trip to the Gold Coast for the Magic Millions Fillies and Mares (1300m) on January 17, but her trainer was reluctant to make plans on raceday.

"She was a very valuable mare before this, but she's worth even more now, so we're not going to force anything. We'll just let her get home, let the dust settle, and if she's pulled up well, there's a flight for her on Tuesday, but no pressure," Yeomans said.

Jenni The Fox's win also completed a double for jockey Tom Stockdale, who earlier scored on Darkbonee (Palentino).

## Precious Charm digs deep in Coastal Classic

Harry Coffey claimed she was not at her best, but Precious Charm (Per Incanto) was still able to continue her fruitful summer with success in the Coastal Classic (1700m) at Geelong on Saturday. The Symon Wilde-trained mare turned in a gritty performance on the Good 3 track to beat Verdad (Justify) by 0.2 lengths. The victory came four weeks after she shared the spoils with Holymanz (Almanzor) in the Werribee Cup (1600m) and Coffey said the merit of the win was much greater than the winning margin. "I don't think she was at her best and she showed a real will to win," the winning rider said. "She might have been feeling that firm ground on the back-up, so it took a lot of urging to get her to win, but she may have been looking after herself. That's understandable, she's done a great job, she's been racing in true heart and this track's starting to get firm now and I don't know if that's right in her wheelhouse." With Wilde en route back to Warrnambool with his earlier winner, Darkbonee, racing manager Ben Casanelia was left to represent the stable and he said: "It has been a fantastic preparation and she has always probably had the ability but it's taken some time to get there and it has all come together for her. She had no weight and she was drawn well. She is in form and the negatives were probably the harder track and the back-up because you're never quite sure how mares will back up. She put it together and Harry rode her an absolute treat."

## Moana Spirit stamps Blue Diamond claims

Promising filly Moana Spirit (Tagaloa) kept her unbeaten record intact and entered calculations for the \$2 million Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) after she scored a convincing victory in the \$150,000 Geelong Diamond (1100m).

Prepared by Tony and Calvin McEvoy, the daughter of Tagaloa (Lord Kanaloa) debuted with a win at Morphettville over 1000 metres on December 6.

On Saturday at Geelong, the filly confirmed that promise with a strong on-speed performance under Luke Currie, beating Ghana's Akan (Street Boss) by two lengths.

Despite her flawless start to racing, the McEvoy camp remains measured in its expectations, while acknowledging the filly's upside as she continues to strengthen.

"She's a beautiful, laid-back filly and very unassuming," Calvin McEvoy said. "She was quite raw in her work going towards Adelaide and we didn't expect a huge amount. She went over there, she won, and since she returned to Flemington, we noticed that she'd really switched on and I thought her jump-out in between was fantastic."

Currie echoed those sentiments after the race, noting the filly's sharp acceleration as her standout asset.

"She's improved a lot," Luke Currie added. "She jumped out really well, but I didn't think that she was going probably quite as well as some of the others at the time.

"Today she was really dynamic. She jumped well as she always has and just speaking with Calvin before, she probably looks like she still needs to furnish a little bit. Her main attribute would be her turn-of-foot.

"She jumped well again, there was solid pressure from both sides, I came back, and she had the right run, got onto the favourite's back cornering and she was really sharp when I asked her."

A homebred for Yulong Investments, Moana Spirit may now follow a familiar path towards Victoria's premier juvenile contest.

A start in the Blue Diamond Preview (F) (Gr 3, 1000m) at Caulfield on January 24 is likely, ahead of the Group 1 on February 21.

"Everything about her tells us that she's going to be better at three, but she's two from two, she's won her way in today," McEvoy added. "We might keep her a fresh head towards a Preview maybe and then hopefully she's there for the Blue Diamond."

Yulong will offer the filly's Alabama Express (Redoute's Choice) half-sister as Lot 550 at the Inglis Premier Yearling Sale, which gets under way in Melbourne on March 1.

## Leonchroi impresses at Geelong

Progressive stayer Leonchroi (Contributer) scored a narrow victory in the Benchmark 70 (2400m) at Geelong on Saturday under a perfectly-timed run by Logan Bates. The Mick Price and Michael Kent Jnr-trained gelding stayed on well to beat Navy Heart (U S Navy Flag) by 0.2 lengths with Hot Too Go (Too Darn Hot) another 0.1 lengths back in third. "We were following the right ones and were able to get out eventually, probably a little later than I would have liked," Bates said. "But one thing I do know about him, he's got a good turn-of-foot for a stayer, which not many of them have. He was a couple kilos up in the weights today, but I still trusted he would have that zip to put himself there and in the end he just did enough. He's not the greatest beginner and he stepped okay considering all the commotion we had pre-race and we got into a decent spot following one of the key runners and it just had to drag us in and

the horse did the rest. He's a lovely horse and a promising stayer." Raced by Grand Syndicates, the four-year-old gelding has now won two of his nine starts with a further four placings. Co-trainer Michael Kent Jnr said the horse would now have a break and return a better horse next campaign.

## Jewel Bandit springs surprise

Despite showing greenness, the Mark and Levi Kavanagh-trained Jewel Bandit (Pierata) still made a good impression in winning her second race in as many starts when she scored over 1100 metres at Geelong. Jewel Bandit won on debut at Cranbourne over 1000 metres on December 12 with Brad Rawiller aboard but Michael Dee took the ride at Geelong, the pair scoring by a half-length over the Mick Price and Michael Kent Jnr-trained Frostrnip (Frosted). The daughter of Pierata (Pierro) was bought for \$20,000 at the 2024 Adelaide Magic Millions Sale, with her prize-money nearly five times that figure after Saturday's win. Co-trainer Mark Kavanagh noted how a smaller spend can go a long way for owners - particularly for syndicates - and there can be more to come from the filly. "Twenty grand, it just goes to show, dreams come true," Kavanagh said. "[He was] \$21 at Cranbourne, but he won like he should have been favourite and I was quite surprised where the market had this horse today and it was proved wrong," Dee added. "We

She is the first foal out of Listed placed mare Pullyoursocksup (Thewayyouare), herself the daughter of Listed winner Grace Park (Danske), making her a full sister to Listed winner and Group 1 placegetter Prince Mambo

Out of the Listed-winning Nicconi (Bianconi) mare Exclusive Lass, Lassified was bought by Glenbeigh Farm for \$70,000 at the Inglis Great Southern Weanling Sale, before selling to her trainer and Andrew Williams for \$110,000 at the Inglis Classic Yearling Sale. The filly is a half-sister to the Group 2-placed winner Boyfriend (Snitzel) and to fellow winners Cape Breton (Vancouver) and Midwest Princess (King's Legacy). Stay Inside stood for a fee of \$66,000 (inc GST), up from \$55,000 in 2024.

## La Dorada back to brilliant best in Levin thriller

The Mark Walker and Sam Bergerson-trained La Dorada (3 f Super Seth - Gold Fever by Savabeel) returned to her brilliant best when she landed the Levin Classic (Gr 2, 1400m) at Trentham on Saturday.

The filly was victorious over the same track and distance when taking out last season's Manawatu Sires' Produce Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) on her way to being crowned Champion New Zealand Two-Year-Old.

She has been disappointing in her subsequent three starts as a three-year-old, finishing second-to-last and last in the Moir Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m) and Scarborough Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) respectively in Australia before a subpar fourth-placed run when resuming at Te Rapa last month.

Owned by Te Akau, the three-year-old filly defeated Swiss Prince (El Roca) by 0.5 lengths with another 1.8 lengths back to Argo (Almanzor) in third.

Bergerson was trackside, and while he was despondent with her position for much of the journey, he was rapt with her finish

and admitted to being a relieved man post-race.

"It was a massive relief, I can't thank the team enough at home that they have done a fantastic job with her," he said.

"We were scratching our heads after Te Rapa. She did have a good blow after it and we thought there was improvement in her. We kept the work up to her, she has thrived and done really well. We made sure we were up to the mark and it was fantastic to see her bounce back like that.

"When she got shuffled back on the fence and there was no speed, I thought it was going to be a disaster, but it was a great ride and it was great to see her back in form. Hopefully she can come through this well and we can crack on to the Karaka Million."

La Dorada won the TAB Karaka Millions 2YO (RL, 1200m) last year and now looms as a key contender for the \$1.5 million TAB Karaka Millions 3YO (RL, 1600m) at Ellerslie on January 24.

"She has got the good attitude where she loves her racing and she is just so tough," Bergerson said. "I am confident that she can travel home, do everything well, and I am really excited for three weeks' time."

The gelding defeated Tshiebwe (Tarzino) by 0.5 lengths with another 0.3 lengths back to Freddie Time (Time Test) in third. Patterson was rapt to see One Bold Cat return to winning form and is excited to press on and test his charge over two miles for the first time later this month. "It's just fantastic to have a good old horse like him back," he said. "He has been going quite well in Group 1s and I knew he would go well today. He is such a beautiful, relaxed horse and they were going so hard. He is as honest as the day is long. I can't wait for the Wellington Cup. I don't know whether I will run him in the Trentham Stakes, I don't know I have to, he is not carrying a lot of condition, he is pretty hard fit so I will make up my mind whether he goes straight to the Wellington Cup.

He won't get two miles on pedigree, but he will get two miles because he is such a good horse and such a relaxed horse." Further elite-level targets could beckon, with the winner holding a nomination for the Herbie Dyke Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) at Te Rapa next month, a race he placed in two years ago. "The Herbie Dyke is still on the radar with La Crique retired," Patterson said. "It would only take one or two more to drop away and we would probably look at the Herbie Dyke."

## Khanshe scores Group 3 honours

The Fraser Auret-trained Khanshe (5 m Mongolian Khan - Folies Bergere by O'Reilly) added a first Group win to her record when she delivered a stunning win in the Phar Lap Trophy (Gr 3, 1600m) at Trentham on Saturday. Ridden

by Matt Cameron, who was winning the mile feature for fourth time, the mare beat Doctor Askar (Derryn) by 2.3 lengths with another 0.1 lengths back to Enrico (El Roca) in third. Auret was delighted to see the patient approach he has taken with the mare beginning to pay off. "It has been a bit of a slow burn with her, and it has taken some time, but she has always had a really good turn of foot," he said. "She has progressed really nicely as that was only her 16th start, so we have given her the time that she needs. She certainly had more work to do [during the race] than I was hoping for, but Matt summed it up nicely and she does like clear air. I think next year could be her year as while she won a stakes race as a three-year-old, she is a very fine boned and weaker type, so we are in no hurry with her. We don't have any set plans as I wanted to get through today with her."

# First Five delivers Greene Group 1 breakthrough

**T**he Rapa visitor First Five (Almanzor) delivered on his enormous potential when he gave trainer David Greene his first Group 1 success when taking out Saturday's Telegraph (Gr 1, 1200m) at Trentham.

Carrying his favourite number 10 saddlecloth, the strapping son of Almanzor (Wootton Bassett) took full advantage of that good omen as he dominated the closing stages of the time-honoured sprint feature to head off the challenge of last year's third placegetter Navigator (El Roca) and the winner of the 2025 contest, Grail Seeker (Iffraaj).

Successful in the J Swap Sprint (Gr 3, 1400m) on his home track at Te Rapa last month, Greene immediately declared the Telegraph as the major target for his charge and never wavered in his faith that this was the horse who could provide him with a Group 1 victory.

Rider Wiremu Pinn took advantage of a good draw as First Five jumped well and put himself right on the speed that was set by outsiders Lhasa (Hellbent) and Party Rocking (Belardo).

Navigator was first to pounce in the home

straight as he dived through against the rail and put more than a length on First Five, who was issuing his challenge three off the fence. As the pair entered a duel, Grail Seeker emerged from the ruck and began to chase hard after them, but at the finish it was First Five and Pinn who held a length advantage over Navigator with a neck further back to Grail Seeker.

Greene has made no secret of the regard he holds First Five in and he cut an emotional figure as he recalled how close he had been to success at elite-level in the past.

"This is unbelievable really and thanks be to God as we have been waiting for a while [to win a Group 1]," Greene said.

"It's pretty special and just great to do it with this group of owners.

"When he [First Five] was sitting outside the leader I was just thinking he looked to be travelling comfortably, but I wasn't sure if that was good or not.

"Wiremu knew what he had underneath him and he was strong all the way through the line.

"To win a Group 1, weight-for-age race at Trentham, it doesn't get any better than this."

Pinn, who had missed the win at Te Rapa through suspension, admitted he was prepared

to ignore Greene's instructions once the barriers opened.

"He is a big, beautiful and strong horse," he said.

"Unfortunately, I was suspended at Te Rapa so I couldn't ride him, so I'm very thankful to David and the owners who have been very loyal to me since the day I started.

"I had my own plans and didn't quite listen to David's instructions as you have to take the bull by the horns in these Group 1 races and there didn't look to be any speed on paper.

"When I did the form, I couldn't put together the puzzle so I thought I'm just going to wing it and luckily it worked.

"I was a little worried up the straight as I saw Navigator go and I didn't think I was going to be able to pick him up, but once I let his head go, he has just flown.

"He was a bit of a sitting duck as he had a good look at the winning post, but he is a really exciting horse."

By Cambridge Stud stallion Almanzor out of the six-race winner Payette (Volksraad), First Five carried the familiar colours of his breeder Gerald Shand who co-owns him along with Jenna McLeod and Jackie and Philip Rogers.

He has now won seven of his 19 starts and more than \$523,000 in prize-money.

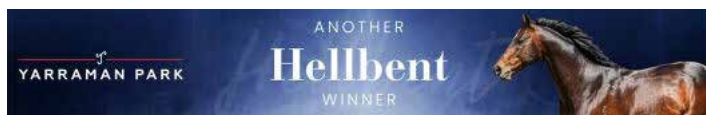

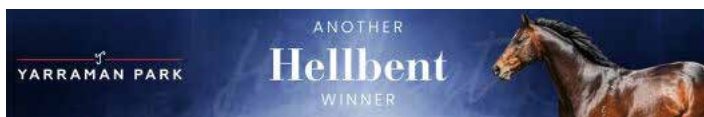
