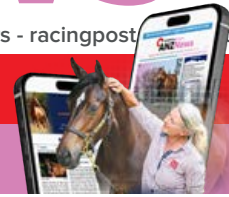

Snitzel show continues at Magic Millions with \$1.6 million session-topper

Lot 504: Snitzel ex Madame Andree filly

Four more seven-figure lots and another session of spirited bidding, particularly for the progeny of the late, great Snitzel (Redoute's Choice), ensured a third buoyant day in succession at the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale.

Auctioneer Grant Burns introduced the daughter of Snitzel out of Madame Andree (War Emblem) by saying "One of the star fillies of 2026, in my humble opinion."

Plainly plenty among the packed auditorium were in agreement, as the bidding

reached a hefty \$1,600,000 by the time the gavel came down. The Arrowfield-consigned youngster went the way of Eugene Chuang's Hermitage Thoroughbreds.

The well-related filly is now a sibling to six winners and five black-type performers, with her three-year-old sister Caffè Florian shedding her maiden since the catalogue was released, and then going on to claim a Gosford Listed contest.

The filly is also a sister to the Group 3-placed Satin Love and is closely related to the Group 3 scorers Ostraka (Pariah) and Anders (Not A Single Doubt), who stands at Widden Stud.

The various names involved in this trade have combined to good effect before. The Hermitage Syndicate races another daughter of Snitzel in three-time Group 1 heroine Lady Shenandoah, while the outfit also campaigned The Autumn Sun (Redoute's Choice), who is now making waves from the Arrowfield roster.

 Moreover, Arrowfield and Hermitage jointly own The Autumn Sun's highest earner, the unbeaten Epsom Handicap (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Autumn Glow.

"There was a lot of competition but she was our top pick for the sale," said Hermitage manager Shannon Clarke. "We've had a lot of luck with a Snitzel filly recently and that's probably guided us on this filly today. That was

our limit, my heart was pounding hoping that we were going to secure her. We've had a lot of luck with Arrowfield. It's a great partnership that we have and long may it continue."

She added: "There's over 100 on the [Hermitage] books at the moment, and 50 of those would be racehorses. We're slowly building up. We've always had a small team but in the past few years we've really built the stable up."

On Autumn Glow, who trialed at Randwick earlier in the day, Clarke said: "She's an exceptional mare and we're just happy to be along for the ride."

By the close of trade, gross sales had reached \$146,142,500, a marginal one per cent increase despite around 30 fewer lots having been offered than at the corresponding stage 12 months ago. The average price was \$281,045 (up one per cent year-on-year) and the median remained the same at A\$200,000. The clearance rate was a notably solid 85.39 per cent as 520 yearlings had found a new home.

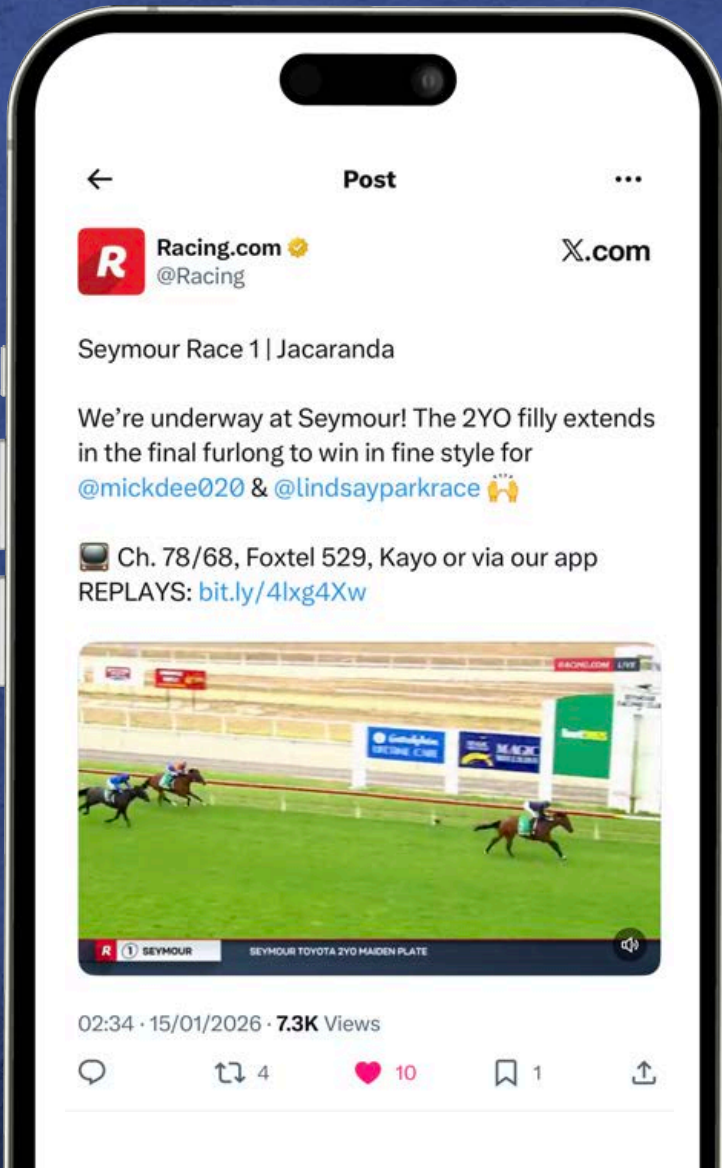

Continued from page 3 “I thought it was consistently strong and genuine across the board,” said Magic Millions managing director Barry Bowditch. “I had a quick debrief with the auctioneers at the end of the day and they

felt as if, even through that 80 [thousand] to 150 bracket, there were plenty of bids coming. It was a good market to be auctioneering in, which is fantastic.

“The average is holding and has been consistent over the week. The median just hasn’t moved at \$200,000, and the clearance rate continues to thrive at above 85 per cent now. These are numbers that are very much in-line with our expectations.”

Bowditch also predicted a strong finale to Book 1, adding: “I think the Howden Super Session will be buzzy. There’ll be a lot of people in town for the races so there’s a lot to look forward to. All in all, I see [Friday] being very, very busy. It just continues to build on itself day by day.”

Harron and TFI run hot

The 12th seven-figure lot of this year’s Gold Coast Yearling Sale arrived late in the session when James Harron, acting with Tony Fung, bid \$1.2m for the Snitzel colt out of the New Zealand-bred Showcasing (Oasis Dream) mare Play That Song.

The Newgate Farm-consigned colt is the first foal out of the Eclipse Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) scorer, who in turn is a half-sister to fellow Group 2 winner and Group 1 placegetter Wild Night (Vanbrugh).

Snitzel, who accounted for the top two lots on Thursday, has been the highest-grossing stallion across the three sessions, with 21 sold lots generating receipts worth \$15.97m. His average price of \$760,475 is second only to Extreme Choice (Not A Single Doubt).

“They’re not making any more by the stallion,” said Harron. “This is a really good, strong, purposeful colt. He’s a lovely medium size and his mother was a sharp two-year-old, so he profiles up **Continued on page 7**

Continued from page 5 really nicely. He comes off a fantastic farm in Newgate, they've got a great record in producing really good horses. That's a big part of our thought process, that gives us confidence investing in these horses."

The signing moved the Harron-Fung colts partnership to the head of the buyers' chart, with seven purchases made for a combined \$5.475m. The group have cost an average of \$782,145 and includes three sons of Snitzel.

"I thought it was an incredible line-up of Snitzels in the catalogue, I was really pleasantly surprised there's so many nice ones," said Harron. "We've been able to pick up three now so we're really happy. Every weekend he's in the headlines and it's a great loss to the industry that he's not with us anymore, but it's brilliant we still have the opportunity to pick up these beautiful colts."

Reflecting on his week so far, Harron said: "It's been great. Once we got through our inspections and went through the shortlist, we



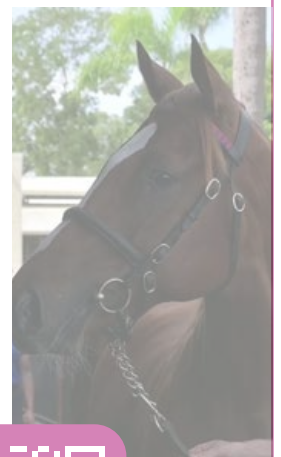
Lot 680: Snitzel ex Play That Song colt

were pleasantly surprised by how many were still on the list and with how deep the catalogue was. Horses have vetted out well and handled

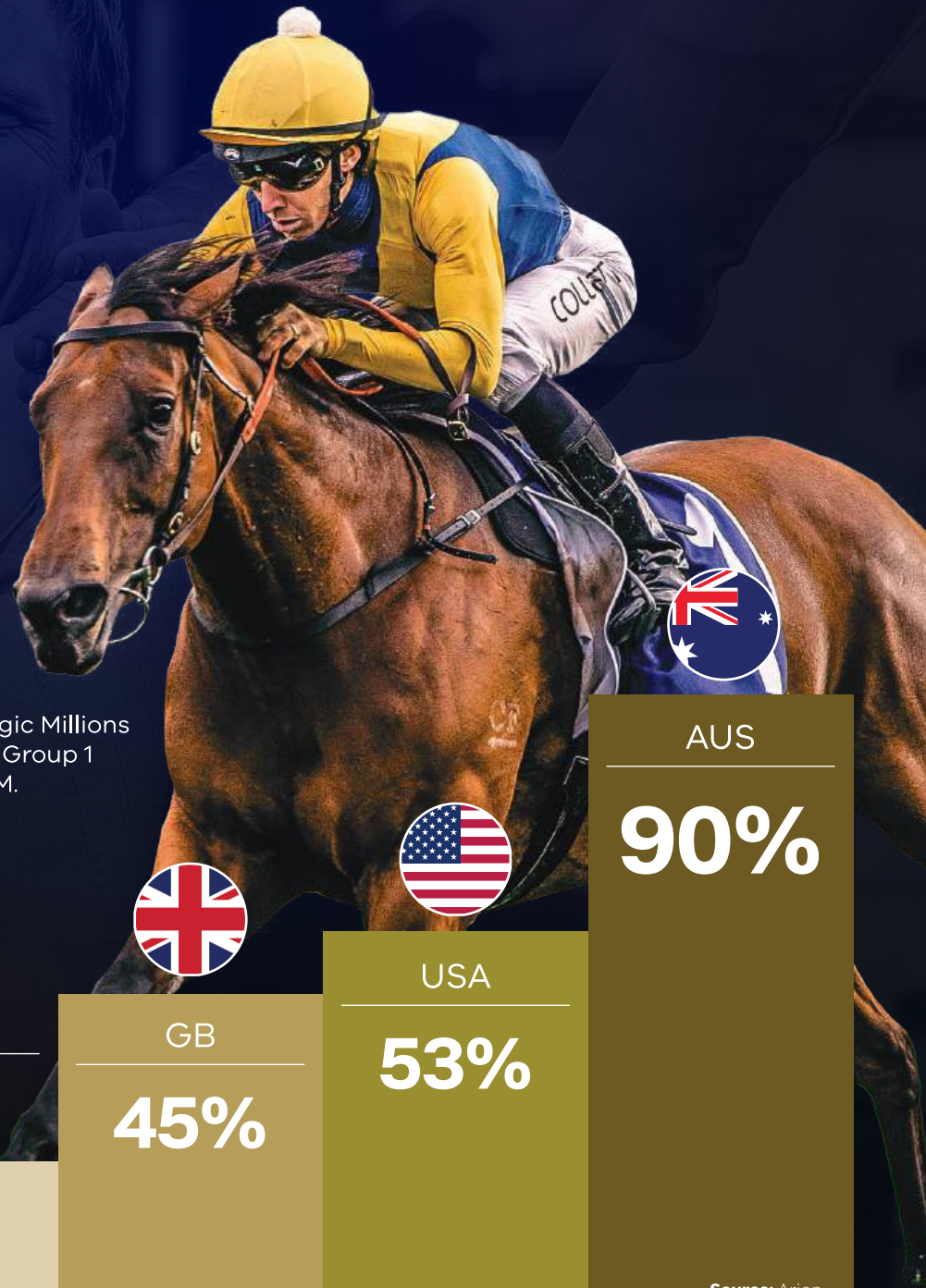
the sale super, so that's given us the confidence to go in and invest alongside our partners and, of course, TFI [Tony Fung Investments]."

Frankel fever

International sire on fire Frankel (Galileo) supplied his second seven-figure yearling of the sale when Harron, once again bidding alongside Fung, went to \$1.1m for the colt out of Miss Alacrity (Munnings) from the Newgate Farm consignment.

The dam is a stakes-winning daughter of Munnings (Speightstown) from the same family as Kentucky Derby (Gr 1, 10f) hero Nyquist (Uncle Mo). She was purchased at the 2022 Fasig-Tipton November Sale, where Harron signed on behalf of Morningside at \$350,000.

"We've been delighted with what we've been able to pick up so far and we're delighted to get a Frankel into the portfolio," said Harron. "He's out of a very fast American mare, she won her maiden as a two-year-old by over ten lengths, which was very impressive. And he comes from the family of Nyquist, who's one of the leading stallions in North America. We were really pleased to see the speed coming through the damside and then the class of Frankel. It's going to be interesting to see what sort of horse he shapes into but he's a beautiful athlete. He's a colt we loved, he's a colt TFI loved, so we felt like we had to have him."

He added: "It's incredibly hard to breed that sort of animal and you have to go to a lot of effort. The mare's come from America, stopped off in Europe to be covered, come down here, foaled down and has had a good specimen.

Everyone respects and appreciates what these horses are worth, and if they're successful on the track, that's when the real fireworks happen."

Earlier in the day a Frankel filly with another blue-chip international page made \$825,000 to the bid of agent Sheamus Mills.

"I loved that stat they kept giving yesterday that Frankel has had 14 stakes horses from something like 70 runners," said Mills. "I thought to myself that's close to 20 per cent, even I'm smart enough to do the maths on that. Our system at the moment is running at 30 per cent stakes performers to purchases. Now, I don't know how to do the maths on that, but if he's 20 per cent and we're 30 per cent, we must have some chance of getting a black-type horse. If you got a black-type horse by Frankel from that family, she could potentially be worth a lot of money."

The Three Bridges Thoroughbreds-consigned filly is the first foal out of Lolloping, a winning daughter of War Front (Danzig) and New Zealand champion Bounding (Lonhro), who gained her Group 1 laurels in the Railway Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m).

In turn, Bounding is out of Believe'N'Succeed (Exceed And Excel), who is best known for breeding star-crossed Derby (Gr 1, 1m 4f) hero Anthony Van Dyck (Galileo).

"A lot of the Frankels that come out here come in utero from European or American

families," said Mills. "It was definitely an extra little dig that if she puts black type up in the first dam, the rest of the page is very recognisable, and not only here but recognisable almost worldwide. If we can jag a little bit of black type, she elevates herself to a pretty rare commodity as a broodmare prospect."

Expanding on the filly's physical traits, Mills said: "I think she's a little bit sharper than most by the sire, which is another thing that drew me to her. I said to the boys, if she's going to be a good horse I think she'll be a 1,000 Guineas type. I don't think she'll be straight out speed, I don't think she'll be winning a Blue Diamond, but I do think she looks sharp enough that sprinter-miler will be her go."

Waterhouse and Bott get to work

Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott were quick out of the traps, bidding \$1m for just the fifth lot into the ring.

The Segenhoe Stud-consigned filly is by I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit) and is the second foal out of Lankan Star, a two-time winner by Nicconi (Bianconi) who possessed enough talent to finish runner-up in the Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) in 2019.

"She's a beauty," said Bott, who signed the docket alongside Bruce Slade's Kestrel Thoroughbreds. "That's a lovely way to start the day and should give us a bit of pep in our step. Delighted we were able to secure her, that was probably around where we wanted to land. We probably didn't have too much more after that.

"She's a real quality filly and a great one to get excited for. The way she presented, the way she handled the sale, it all profiles up really well with her breeding. She's by a champion sire and out of a very fast and precocious mare. Hopefully her daughter is every bit the same."

Continued from page 9 He added: "The farm did an immaculate job in presenting her and she handled the sale really well, she looks an ultimate professional type. Hopefully that's the way she remains throughout her racing career."

Reflecting on the first half of the sale, Bott said: "Happy with where we're at and there's still a bit more to go. We've missed on plenty of lots that other people have been strong on, but you've just got to pick your mark and back yourself and do what you need to to secure the ones you really want. You need to be strong on those."

Maher moves for Vinnie filly

Leading trainer Ciaron Maher continued to Hoover up well-credentialed prospects on Thursday, including the I Am Invincible filly out of Mumbai Rock (Fastnet Rock). The youngster was offered by Coolmore on behalf of Morning Rise Stud and brought the hammer down at \$950,000.

The dam, a daughter of leading broodmare sire Fastnet Rock (Daneshill), has bred six winners from as many runners, including her Listed-winning sister Jazz Etude and Red Roses Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) scorer Mumbai Muse (Zoustar).

"An imposing type, a big, strong Vinnie filly," was how the stable's head of bloodstock Will

Bourne summed up their latest recruit. "Ciaron's had a lot of luck with similar types, horses like Loving Gaby. She's a horse with plenty of residual so it's not like we're completely gambling, per se. Hopefully she can justify the price tag, but at the end of the day she's still worth a fair bit of money if she's unraced. There's a bit of protection there."

He added: "She's out of a proven mare, by a proven sire, so I'm hoping it's a proven purchase. It's a bit of a motley Brisbane crew

involved, truth be told, so hopefully we can get her up here at some stage."

Panther-like movement sees Wootton Bassett colt bring \$900,000

Catheryne Bruggeman and Paul Moroney made their biggest purchase of the week when bidding \$900,000 for Coolmore's Wootton Bassett (Iffraaj) colt. The youngster is the third foal out of Miss Que (Fastnet Rock), a Group 3-placed sister to Theo Marks Stakes (Gr 2, 1300m) scorer Cluster.

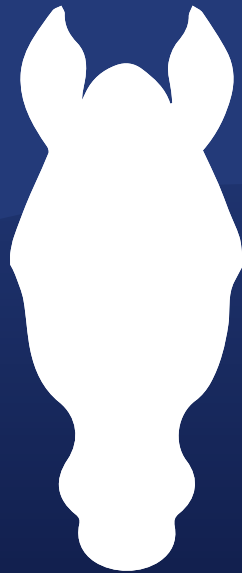
"We're delighted to have bought him," said Moroney. "We're working with one of the stallion syndicates. They came and asked us to pinpoint what we thought were the top ten yearlings to be potential racehorses and then stallions later on in life, and he fell into the category. He was right at the top of the list. We don't think he's going to make an early two-year-old type but with Wootton Bassett, you never know.

“He’s a big scopey horse and looks like an autumn two-year-old, could be a Sires’ Produce and Guineas type. Catheryne and I loved the way he moved, he just floated over the ground; he moved like a panther. There was nothing you could fault him on. He had a bit more scope than the sireline can throw, but there’s speed in the family so I’m not saying he won’t get up and do it at two. But whatever he does at two, I think at three will be his proper season.”

Moroney said training plans would be decided in due course.

Another for Anamoe

A good sale for Darley’s first-crop sire Anamoe (Street Boss) got even better when Belmont Bloodstock agent Damon Gabbedy bid \$850,000 for the half-brother to Rough Habit Plate (Gr 3, 2000m) scorer Tannhauser (Dundeel), who also finished third in the JJ Atkins (Gr 1, 1600m). The Milburn Creek-consigned colt was secured in conjunction with MyRacehorse, Michael Freedman Racing and Stallion Match.

“We thought he was the best Anamoe in the sale,” said Emma Freedman. “We actually thought he was the best colt in the sale, so we didn’t want to leave without him. The mare has done an amazing job with two stakes performers so he was great on pedigree, he’s great on type and we believe in the stallion. Very excited to get him. We know that our clients at MyRacehorse will dive into him. We’re looking forward to sending him to Michael Freedman racing.”

It promises to be a big few days for the My Racehorse syndicate, as not only have they picked up a host of new recruits at the sale, they also have the odds-on favourite for Saturday’s Magic Millions 3YO Guineas in Ninja.

“We’re flying,” said Freedman. “Damon Gabbedy, our bloodstock agent, and Ben

Willis, our managing director, they’re doing a great job in choosing the right horses. [Group 1 winner] Apocalyptic trialled ultra-well and we’re excited about what the autumn holds for her, and then obviously Ninja is short-priced favourite for the Guineas on Saturday. It’s all about choosing the right trainers, plotting the right path for them, and hopefully this guy can be in a similar mould.”

She added: “That’s five bought and we’re not done yet. We still have a women’s syndicate to fill and we’re hoping to buy a nice filly, maybe tomorrow.”

Ellis extends spending spree

No individual buyer has been in more prolific form than during the first three sessions than David Ellis.

Thursday saw the Te Akau Racing principal move into double figures, with his 11-strong haul including the Snitzel colt out of the late

dual Group 1 winner Loving Gaby (I Am Invincible).

The colt, who was offered by Vinery Stud, fetched \$800,000 early in the day.

“I thought he was a Golden Slipper colt, I really liked him,” said Ellis. “I thought we’d have to pay a bit more for him so I’m thrilled to get him for \$800,000. We’ve just had so much success with Snitzel colts in New Zealand, and in Australia. It’s a big thrill to get him. I think it’s a very strong market generally; the good horses are making good money.”

Book 1 of the Gold Coast Yearling Sale concludes on Friday, with day four’s Super Session beginning at 10am local time.

How John Warren struck gold while on a 'busman's holiday' at Magic Millions

Highclere Stud's John and Lady Carolyn Warren were among the breeders toasting a big result at the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale on Thursday after their half-brother to Group 1 performer Tannhauser (Dundeel) sold for \$850,000.

The youngster, who is set to sport the My Racehorse silks for trainer Michael Freedman, is by Darley's red-hot first-crop sire Anamoe (Street Cry). The nine-time Group 1 scorer is tied with Rebel's Romance (Dubawi) as Godolphin's most prolific elite-level winner.

"We had huge regard for the sire when he was racing, you couldn't not," said John Warren. "Such a phenomenal horse who did it at two, three and four, and he even placed in the Golden Slipper. We went to see him at James Cummings' while he was in training because we wanted to use him and we were very impressed.

"We have four or five mares here in Australia and it's just great fun to dabble and be able to use horses of that calibre. A little bit of diversification is part of our business plan and it's such a strong and broad market here."

Warren said the team from Milburn Creek deserved all the plaudits for producing the six-figure colt.

"From the day he was born we've had great reports," he continued. "We came to see him last year as a foal and were impressed with him back then. Milburn Creek deserve all the credit. It's the most beautiful farm, an hour and a half south of Sydney in the southern highlands.

"They've got a phenomenal team, headed by Scott Holcombe, who's an outstanding horseman. Living so far away, it's always difficult to get a handle on your stock, but he treats them all, every horse he rears, like they're his own. The feedback is fantastic, so we've enjoyed the journey."

The Anamoe colt had been the subject of some positive whispers among the judges on the ground, and Warren said confidence within the camp had also been high leading up to the sale.

"When we arrived two weeks ago and saw him at the farm, he fulfilled all that we'd heard about him," he said. "We saw all of the Anamoes when we came to the sale and were very impressed, but we sensed he was right up there physically. He ticked the boxes and we're grateful to Milburn Creek for doing such a great job."

Warren described his annual trip to the Gold Coast as "a busman's holiday", praising the Magic Millions team for orchestrating an event where business and pleasure go hand in hand.

"This place is remarkable," he said. "Magic Millions, their promotional team, the energy behind it, it's very impressive. This is the equivalent of the summer holidays for children, everyone's migrated down here and there's such a buzz and atmosphere. It's a really good experience to witness how it unfolds.

"These things don't happen lightly and they put a huge amount of effort into it. Barry Bowditch [managing director] is really on the ball, and Gerry [Harvey] and Katie [Page-Harvey, co-owners] are just remarkable."

While Warren was more concerned with selling on this occasion, he suggested the timing of the sale presented an interesting proposition for those looking to unearth a future star.

“If you convert this to Britain, this is the equivalent of selling yearlings at the beginning of July,” he said. “You’re dealing with a thousand immature horses, and that’s what makes this sale fascinating. You’ve got to view them, not just based on what they look like today, you’ve got to visualise what they’re going to be like in 18 months’ time. That’s the fun.”

Highclere’s Australian endeavours have already yielded some notable results, not least Coolangatta (Written Tycoon). She won two Group 1 prizes during her time in training with Ciaron Maher and David Eustace, namely the Moir Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m) and Black Caviar Lightning (Gr 1, 1000m).

Fittingly the barn the Anamoe colt was stabled in this week has been named in honour of Coolangatta.

“That was the first thing we noticed when we came down to look at this colt, we were very proud,” said Warren. “Our few little mares have done us really well.”

Warren reported that the dam of the Anamoe colt is back in foal to Too Darn Hot’s (Dubawi) four-time Group 1-winning son Broadstiding.

He said planning matings on the opposite side of the world is not without its challenges, particularly the legwork of having to remain on top of such a variety of bloodlines and racetrack

results. However, he suggested having to put in the extra due diligence helped sharpen his focus.

“It’s hard work,” he said. “You can’t be that removed and just hope, you have to be tuned in to understand what’s going on. Home is second nature, it’s every day. This has been a really good journey, though.”

Australia

Four for Home Affairs

Coolmore's first-season sire Home Affairs (I Am Invincible) chalked up his fourth individual winner on Thursday when the Ben, Will and JD Hayes-trained Jacaranda (2 f ex Gracie's Lass by Redoute's Choice) ran out a dominant winner of an 1100-metre Seymour maiden on debut. The filly defeated South Yarra Miss (Maurice) by 5.8 lengths under Mick Dee, with a further half-length back to the third-placed Insolence (Street Boss). "I was just a pilot today, she did everything of her own accord," Dee said. "She jumped well and was travelling strongly, so I just let her stride to be outside the leader coming to the turn and she gave a great kick. She's still doing a few things wrong, so there's plenty of upside." Entered for both the Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) and Golden Slipper (Gr 1, 1200m), Jacaranda was a \$300,000 Inglis Easter purchase for Tom Magnier from the Vinery Stud draft and is a half-sister to both dual Group 1 winner turned stallion Artorius (Flying Artie) - who won the Blue Diamond Stakes - and Group-winning three-year-old Sixties (Flying Artie). Bred by Greg Perry, she is the sixth winner from as many foals to race out of the unraced Redoute's Choice (Danehill) mare Gracie's Lass, herself a half-sister to Group 1 winner Delectation (Shamardal) out of US stakes winner Grace And Power (More Than Ready). A half-brother to Jacaranda by Pinatubo (Shamardal) sold to Anthony Freedman Racing and Julian Blaxland Bloodstock for \$120,000 on day one of the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale. Home

Affairs stood the 2025 breeding season for an unchanged fee of \$82,500 (inc GST).

Tulloch Lodge to have quartet in 2YO Classic

Tulloch Lodge will send out a quartet of runners in Saturday's Magic Millions 2YO Classic (RL, 1200m) at the Gold Coast. The stable will be represented by colt Knightsbridge (Farnan) and fillies Shiki (Too Darn Hot), Lumbini (Russian Revolution) and By Choice (Written By) in the \$3 million feature, and co-trainer Adrian Bott is hoping that he can add to his win with Storm Boy (Justify) in the 2YO Classic back in 2024. "You can make a good case for each of them going into it," Bott, who trains in partnership with Gai Waterhouse, said. "I won't name a top seed but we've probably taken confidence off the horses that have won their most recent runs." Last-start Aquis Gold Pearl (1100m) winner Shiki is the shortest of the four in the betting, currently sitting at \$12. "Shiki, there's good timing about her win, she looked to do it very well. She looked very sharp, so a lot to like," Bott said. "Knightsbridge is a horse I've always had an opinion of. Things didn't work out for him in the spring. I thought he really came back and stamped his authority there at Randwick [first up]. It's 1000 to 1200 [metres], but I think that'll suit. Lumbini could be forgiven for her run last time. She might have been a touch disappointing on face value, but she still ran very well behind the favourite [Warwoven], and her first-up win was explosive. I thought she's improved off that. Similarly, By Choice was excellent first up. She had no luck behind Shiki there the other day, she was wide and covered

ground and just sort of lost her balance around the turn, but she was good late so she can easily bounce back."

Tigrone chasing big payday on Gold Coast

Despite being a maiden after her three starts to date, the John O'Shea and Tom Charlton-trained Tigrone (Tiger Of Malay) will be given a chance to secure a huge payday when she lines up in Saturday's Magic Millions 2YO Classic. The juvenile daughter of Tiger Of Malay (Extreme Choice), who was third in last Saturday's Aquis Gold Pearl, will not only be racing for the lion's share of the \$3 million prize but she is one of just three runners in the 1200-metre contest eligible for the Magic Millions' Racing Women's Bonus, which offers an extra \$500,000 in incentives to horses owned solely by women, an incentive that Charlton admitted is very difficult to pass up. "Once she was trialling well back in October time and then raced very well first-up it was probably the obvious target, particularly given she's a ladies syndicate horse," Charlton said. "She had a little freshen up and then ran well again when third behind By Choice and then, again, we were happy with her run on Saturday when things probably didn't quite go to plan. So, this is a race we've targeted. We're under no illusion, but if there's a few chinks in the armours of the top picks then she might be a good top-three chance."

The son of Showcasing (Oasis Dream) has landed the Christmas Cup (Listed, 2400m) and Bagot Handicap (Listed, 2800m) on his last two outings, and Maher has revealed that the drop back to 2000 metres coupled with recent rainfall could mean he misses out on Saturday. "I've got to work out what I'm going to do for the race," Maher said. "I'm sort of targeting him at next week, and I'll work out whether I'm backing him up or not." The Australia Day Cup (Listed, 2400m) at Warwick Farm on Monday, January 26 could be one race of interest to Maher. "It depends on the race shape. If he leads, it doesn't matter how far the race is," Maher said. "You question whether he'd go 2800 [metres] before last run, but when they just canter along, it doesn't matter whether it's 2000 or 3000 [metres]. It's just whether the race shape works for him because he likes to dictate and get his own way. You could run him every day, one hundred per cent. It just depends on the track [whether he runs this weekend], if it's wet I'll probably just pull him out."

Unspoken has run solid races on his last four starts, including fourth-placed efforts in November's Ichiban Plate (Listed, 1800m) and ATC Cup (Listed, 2000m) before a last-start third in the Summer Cup (Gr 3, 2000m) at Randwick in December. "His runs have been good and a bit of dampness in the track won't hurt him either," Snowden told Racing NSW. "He'd be the favoured one, he's rock hard fit. I was a bit surprised he got as much weight because he hasn't won for a while, he's running placings and fourths, so it's a bit of a turnaround for Touristic in his favour." Meanwhile, Touristic has been slightly less positive in his two starts this campaign, running well down the field in the Festival Stakes (Gr 3, 1500m) before a most recent seventh in the Summer Cup. "He's only had a couple of runs, the tracks have been firm for him but his runs have still been good. It won't surprise me at all to see him run very well," Snowden said. "He's got to get soft ground. On the firm tracks he looms to win and just fades out the last bit but you give him a wet track he keeps running through the line. In a small field he won't be too far away, in bigger fields he gets further back and has more work to do, and Unspoken will be up on the speed in the first few. He's ready to fire and he gets the right conditions to suit. They're still on the way up in their preps and they're going in with good work and good form under their belts. Both are a good chance."

Freedman brothers set to dominate Rosehill race

Freedman brothers Michael, Richard and Anthony will all have a runner in Saturday's Bisley Workwear Handicap (1100m) at Rosehill in a rarely seen moment. Michael Freedman will saddle up Outspan (Bivouac) for his second start after a debut fifth behind Magic Millions 2YO Classic contender Knightsbridge, Richard Freedman will send out debutant Written In Munny (Written Tycoon) alongside his son

Will, while Anthony Freedman, who trains in partnership with his son Sam, also sends out Pinatubo (Shamardal) colt Zambales for his debut. "We've all had a runner in the same race before, but I don't think it's happened with first starters," Richard Freedman said. "I think the weather will play a part on whether that actually takes place. We're always sort of wary with that sort of stuff." Written In Munny ran fifth in an 850-metre trial at Randwick-Kensington on December 18 before then winning a 900-metre trial at Rosehill on January 2. "He's a nice horse," Freedman said. "He's fast, he's got speed. He showed that in his trial, he's just got to convert that to race performance. He was probably a little left in the tank, but he ran a second and a half quicker than any other trial, including group horses. He's a nice horse, he can go on and he'll probably be a better three-year-old."

Big Sky to make debut at Flemington

They may already have the current market leader for the Blue Diamond but Mick Price and Michael Kent Jnr are hopeful of adding another juvenile to their potential runners when Big Sky (Bivouac) makes his debut at Flemington on Saturday. Markets for the Blue Diamond went up during the week and have impressive debut winner Guest House (Home Affairs) as the \$6 favourite, while Big Sky is only at \$15 despite having yet to make his first start in Saturday's Tab We're On Handicap (1000m). "He's a nice horse," Price, who won the Blue Diamond with Samaready (More Than Ready) in 2012 and Extreme Choice (Not A Single Doubt) in 2016, said. "When Ben Melham trialed him at his second trial, I thought he was quite impressive. And Melham is up here, obviously, so very happy to have Mark Zahra on. He had a gallop on Monday morning on the grass and sat off one, ran good time and recovered very well. So we had the data on him and the data's very good, and I expect him to be hard to beat."

I think with the two-year-olds, timing is very important. He was in the zone where he was right, so from his trial to his Monday morning gallop to the race, it's a good rhythm and it's good prize money. It will stand him in good stead if he does win to take that form into the [Blue Diamond] Prelude over 1100 metres into the Blue Diamond that way. I wasn't sure that he'd be suited in a 1000-metre [Blue Diamond] Preview. The Preview's quite fast, and I think he's a horse that will just get a bit balanced and I think the straight will suit him."

Tarvue to back up at HQ

Last Saturday's Benchmark 78 (1800m) winner Tarvue (Tarzino) will be back at Flemington this weekend as she bids to make it back-to-back victories at the track. The John Sadler-trained daughter of Tarzino (Tavistock) scored by 1.3 lengths over I Only Wish (Puissance De Lune) last weekend, and Sadler now raises the mare up to 2520 metres as he bids to get the five-year-old into the Adelaide Cup (Gr 2, 3200m). "She's had lots of feet problems which have really interrupted her career so far," Sadler told Racing.com. "I don't think we've ever seen the best of her until possibly last Saturday where we saw a glimpse of what we've been hoping for. Of course, the query is the 1800 metres to the 2500 metres, but she would have been better at 2000 metres last week. I don't think the 2500 metres is going to be a worry." Sadler will also run Merrigold (Gold Standard) in the \$175,000 VOBIS Gold Reef (1600m) at Flemington, following a third placing in a Benchmark 74 (1400m) at Geelong on January 3. "Last campaign, she had a ripper, she had seven runs for four wins and three seconds but this time, it's just been luckless," Sadler said. "Hopefully, she has a bit of luck on Saturday. I've always thought 1400 metres and a bit would have been her limit. We're stretching her out to a mile, everybody's keen, including myself, to see if she can run it or not. We'll find out."

Farnan filly provides timely boost for Magic Millions purchase

Unraced Farnan (Not A Single Doubt) filly Better By Far provided a timely boost for her yearling half-sister when winning the quickest of the Randwick juvenile trials on Thursday, beating her rivals by 2.7 lengths and clocking 44.35 for 740 metres.

The Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott-trained filly defeated Oh Yes She Did (Yes Yes Yes) into second with Naadra (Tassort) another half-length away in third.

Thursday's trial win came two days after Capri Racing & Syndication Pty Ltd and trainer Peter Snowden went to \$130,000 for her half-sister by Russian Revolution (Snitzel) on day one of the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale.

The pair are the first two foals out of Listed-winning Better Than Ready (More Than Ready) mare Better Reflection, who sold to Daandine Stud and Boomer Bloodstock for \$420,000 at the 2023 Magic Millions National Broodmare Sale. Daandine Stud sold Better By Far to her trainers and

Kestrel Thoroughbreds for \$180,000 on the Gold Coast last year.

One heat earlier and unraced Home Affairs (I Am Invincible) filly Coco Affair showed a nice turn of foot in the straight to win eased down by 0.1 lengths over Celestial Charm (Extreme Choice). The runner-up is out of Group 1 winner I Am A Star (I Am Invincible) and her Newgate Farm-consigned full-sister sold to Shane Nichols for \$575,000 at Magic Millions on Wednesday.

The John O'Shea and Tom Charlton-trained Coco Affair has a half-brother by Zoustar (Northern Meteor) catalogued as **Lot 562** for the Inglis Premier Yearling Sale.

Thursday's third juvenile heat was won by Annabel and Rob Archibald's Extreme Warrior (Extreme Choice) colt Half Pipe, who was landing his second trial as he beat Eviction Notice (Stay Inside) by 0.2 lengths, with First Act (I Am Invincible) – the half-brother to Wodeton (Wootton Bassett) – the same margin further back in third.

Jadzia sharpens Blue Diamond credentials at Sandown

Unraced Ole Kirk (Written Tycoon) filly Jadzia took a significant step toward the Blue Diamond Stakes with a stylish 900-metre trial victory at Sandown on Thursday morning. Prepared by Grahame Begg, the lightly raced filly showed a sharp change of gear under Jordan Childs, settling back before finishing strongly to stamp herself as a genuine prospect for the Group 1 at Caulfield on February 21. Childs, who rode Begg's Written By (Written Tycoon) to Blue Diamond glory in 2018, was pleased with both the performance and the education Jadzia took from the hit-out, her second public outing after a solid Cranbourne jump-out late last year. "It's a long way to get there, but she's heading the right way," Childs told Racing.com. "Her first jump-out was good and she was even better today. From an educational point of view it was perfect. She jumped out of the barriers nicely and I was able to get cover in behind. I then asked her to quicken, took her off the bridle a little to teach her how to stretch out and lengthen to the line. She's a pretty smart horse heading the right way. Once I gave her a squeeze, she was right there in my hands. She's got a nice turn of foot." Purchased for \$65,000 by the Flying Start Syndicate at last year's Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale, Jadzia could make her debut in the Blue Diamond Preview (Listed, 1000m) at Caulfield on January 24.

Oakleigh Plate task for Point Barrow

Daniel Stackhouse came away from Sandown on Thursday with mixed emotions after giving connections a glowing report on emerging star Point Barrow (Blue Point) following her first trial of the year. The Anthony and Sam Freedman-trained filly cruised through her opening hit-out with a soft fourth placing, but Stackhouse

concedes he is unlikely to be aboard when she steps out at Group 1 level as early as next month. Stackhouse has partnered Point Barrow in five of her six starts, however her likely tilt at the Oakleigh Plate (Gr 1, 1100m) on February 21 is expected to see her attract the minimum weight, effectively ruling him out of the ride. "I've had discussions with Sam [Freedman] about the weight she might get and it looks like she could be down around 50 kilos, which is a bit outside my comfort zone," Stackhouse told Racing.com. "I probably won't be able to ride her first-up and hopefully get back on her after that." Point Barrow has won four times, announcing herself as a filly of genuine class with a devastating last-to-first victory at Group 3 level over 1100 metres at Flemington during the spring carnival. "She's furnished a lot and mentally she's improved again," Stackhouse said. "She does have that Group 1 quality and I think she'll add that to her résumé pretty quickly. We're tinkering with a few things and put a noseband on her just to help her not over-race; she settled into a nice rhythm, dropped her head and stretched out really well. She couldn't have done it any better."

the second heat at the Randwick trials on Thursday. McEvoy forfeited his rides on the day at Beamont, as well as his books at Canterbury and the Gold Coast on Friday and Saturday respectively.

Zahra a doubt for the autumn

The autumn carnival is in serious doubt for Mark Zahra after the leading rider was confirmed to have fractured his tibia following an incident at the Sandown trials on Thursday. The Victorian Jockeys' Association confirmed on Thursday afternoon that Zahra sustained a shin injury in a barrier mishap, with scans later revealing a fracture. The timing is a major blow, with Zahra set to play a pivotal role across the early autumn features. He had confirmed rides aboard Black Caviar Lightning Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m) and Newmarket Handicap (Gr 1, 1200m) favourite Tentryis (Street Boss), as well as Victoria Derby (Gr 1, 2500m) winner Observer (Ghaiyyath), who is being aimed at the Australian Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m). Zahra was also set for a strong book of rides at Saturday's Flemington meeting, with several short-priced chances now requiring replacement jockeys. The injury also halts Zahra's momentum in the Melbourne jockeys' premiership, where he held a commanding lead with 36 winners – ten clear of Craig Williams and 13 ahead of Blake Shinn, who has been sidelined since the spring with a broken leg.

both the Breeders' Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) and Thompson Handicap (Gr 3, 1600m) in October. Trainer and part-owner Kim Reid had hoped to push on to elite-level targets, but a foot issue intervened. "She had a nail go into her foot the week prior to the Mufhasa, so that put us on the backburner for a couple of weeks," Reid said. "It was a bit of a rollercoaster." Since then, Hi Yo Sass Bomb has built steadily and caught the eye in an exhibition gallop at New Plymouth, before another solid hit-out at home last weekend. "I thought I might have flattened her with that gallop, but she's bounced through it and has been really bright this week," Reid said. "She feels like she's flying." Reid concedes Saturday presents a stiff assignment first-up, but believes the mare is tough enough to measure up, with bookmakers installing her a \$7 third favourite behind Legarto (Proisir) and Queen Zou (Zoustar). "She's had a bit of time off, but she's very genuine. I'm expecting a nice run." Looking ahead, the Herbie Dyke Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) at Te Rapa looms as her next major target.

High hopes for Queen Zou at Trentham

Stephen Marsh will chase a third win in Saturday's Thorndon Mile at Trentham and believes Queen Zou can again be a major player, provided conditions fall her way. Queen Zou returns after a decisive New Year's Day victory in the Rich Hill Mile (Gr 2, 1600m) at Ellerslie. The Zoustar (Northern Meteor) mare again carries 53 kilograms with Matt Cartwright retaining the ride. "It's a very even field and if she gets the right track conditions, I think she'll race extremely well," Marsh said. "She's in good form off that Group 2 win and has gone forward since. I just hope we don't get too much rain." Marsh also has a strong hand across the weekend. Promising filly In Your Dreams (Per Incanto) steps sharply up in class in the Desert Gold Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m) after an

encouraging debut third at Rotorua. "She's well above average and the big mile at Trentham should suit her if the track's good," he said. In the Gee & Hickton Funeral Directors Sprint (1100m), Miss Fladgate (Russian Revolution) is expected to be competitive after two wins and a solid third at Ellerslie on Boxing Day. Looking ahead to Sunday at Pukekohe, Marsh is expecting a form turnaround from Roctave (Roc De Cambes) over 2200 metres, while smart debutant Lunaman (Reliable Man) will provide clarity on whether his path leads toward the NZB Kiwi (Listed, 1500m) or the New Zealand Derby (Gr 1, 2400m).

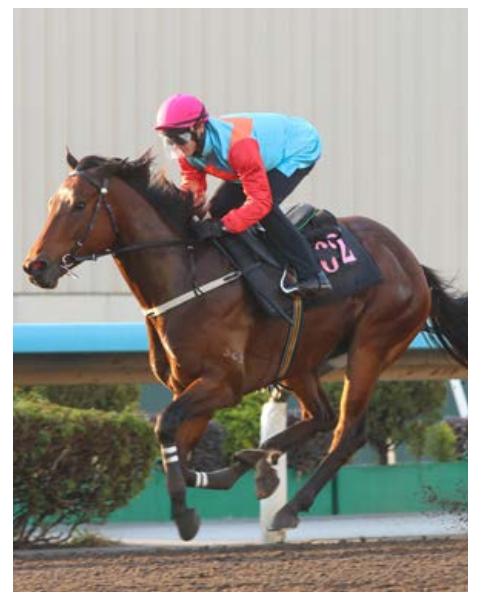
Stakes targets in the offing for Brave Spirit

Stakes ambitions are on the radar for in-form gelding Brave Spirit (Swiss Ace) if he can maintain his momentum in Saturday's 1400-metre open contest at Wingatui. The six-year-old has thrived since joining trainer Joseph Waldron, finishing runner-up on debut for the stable at Riccarton in October before breaking through over the same course a month later. He confirmed that progress when stepping into open company for the first time at Wingatui on Boxing Day, scoring decisively over 1200 metres. Waldron has been pleased with how the gelding has come on since and expects him to be well suited back to 1400 metres at his home track. Drawn in barrier three, Brave Spirit will again be partnered by apprentice Triston Moodley. "He should get a perfect run from that draw," Waldron said. "He's been in great form since his last start and his record at 1400 metres is actually better than at 1200 [metres], so I'm really looking forward to seeing him at the trip." A strong performance could open the door to next month's Hazlett Stakes (Listed, 1400m), although Waldron is keeping his options open. "He's done a very good job already this prep, so we'll just take it one run at a time," he said.

Ka Ying Rising impresses in Sha Tin trial

Hong Kong sprinting superstar Ka Ying Rising (Shamexpress) has taken another decisive step toward history, cruising to an effortless barrier trial victory at Sha Tin on Thursday morning ahead of his bid to equal Silent Witness' (El Moxie) long-standing record of consecutive wins. Preparing for the Centenary Sprint Cup (Gr 1, 1200m) on January 25, Ka Ying Rising sped through his 1200-metre dirt trial under Zac Purton in 1:10.36, stretching three and three-quarter lengths clear of Romantic Son (Smart Missile), with Galaxy Patch (Wandjina) third. Trainer David Hayes was delighted with what he saw as the six-time Group 1 winner eyes a 17th consecutive victory. "He jumped as well as I've ever seen him," Hayes said. "His gate speed was incredible, then he was happy to cruise. Zac said he had a healthy blow, which is exactly what we want from this sort of tune-up. He's not going backwards at all and looks right on song for the 25th."

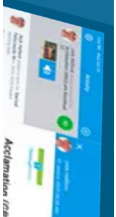

The Ben, Will and JD Hayes-trained Jacaranda (Home Affairs) turned plenty of heads at Seymour on Thursday when producing a memorable debut with a 5.8-length success in the Seymour Toyota Maiden Plate (1100m).

Ridden by Mick Dee, the juvenile filly - who was becoming the fourth individual winner for Coolmore's first-season sire Home Affairs (I Am Invincible) - proved much the best in the three-runner contest as she extended smartly to beat South Yarra Miss (Maurice).

There was a further half-length back to the third-placed Insolence (Street Boss).

"I've got to thank the Hayes boys, I believe this is their first winner since the devastation up there on the farm," Dee told Racing.com.

"I think their spirits are pretty high, but hopefully this lifts the spirits even more. I was just a pilot today, she did everything of her own accord."

Jacaranda has an entry for both next month's Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) and March's Golden Slipper (Gr 1, 1200m), and Lindsay Park's Flemington assistant trainer Rahis Baig believes the filly could go a long way.

"She's been really good. All throughout,

she's shown a lot of ability and talent, and it's good to see her translate what she's done at trackwork and her trials," Baig told Racing.com.

"I think we've got a good horse on our hands, and connections will be very happy with that. She's definitely shown us above-average talent, and in her trials, she looked very sharp, so we were very confident coming into the race today.

"The way she won, she looked really good, and the way she stretched out towards the end, it looks like she's got a lot of talent, so these sorts of races will probably be the ideal targets for her.

"The horse will tell us, in the next couple of days, how she's pulled and then the plans will be made, but the logical options would be heading towards the big races in February and March."

A \$300,000 Inglis Easter purchase for Tom Magnier from the Vinery Stud draft, Jacaranda is a half-sister to both dual Group 1 winner turned stallion Artorius (Flying Artie) - who won the Blue Diamond Stakes - and Group-winning three-year-old Sixties (Flying Artie).

Bred by Greg Perry, she is the sixth winner from as many foals to race out of the unraced Redoute's Choice (Danehill) mare Gracie's Lass, herself a half-sister to Group 1 winner Delectation (Shamardal) out of US stakes winner Grace And Power (More Than Ready).

A half-brother to Jacaranda by Pinatubo (Shamardal) sold to Anthony Freedman Racing and Julian Blaxland Bloodstock for \$120,000 on day one of the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale. Home Affairs stood the 2025 breeding season for an unchanged fee of \$82,500 (inc GST).

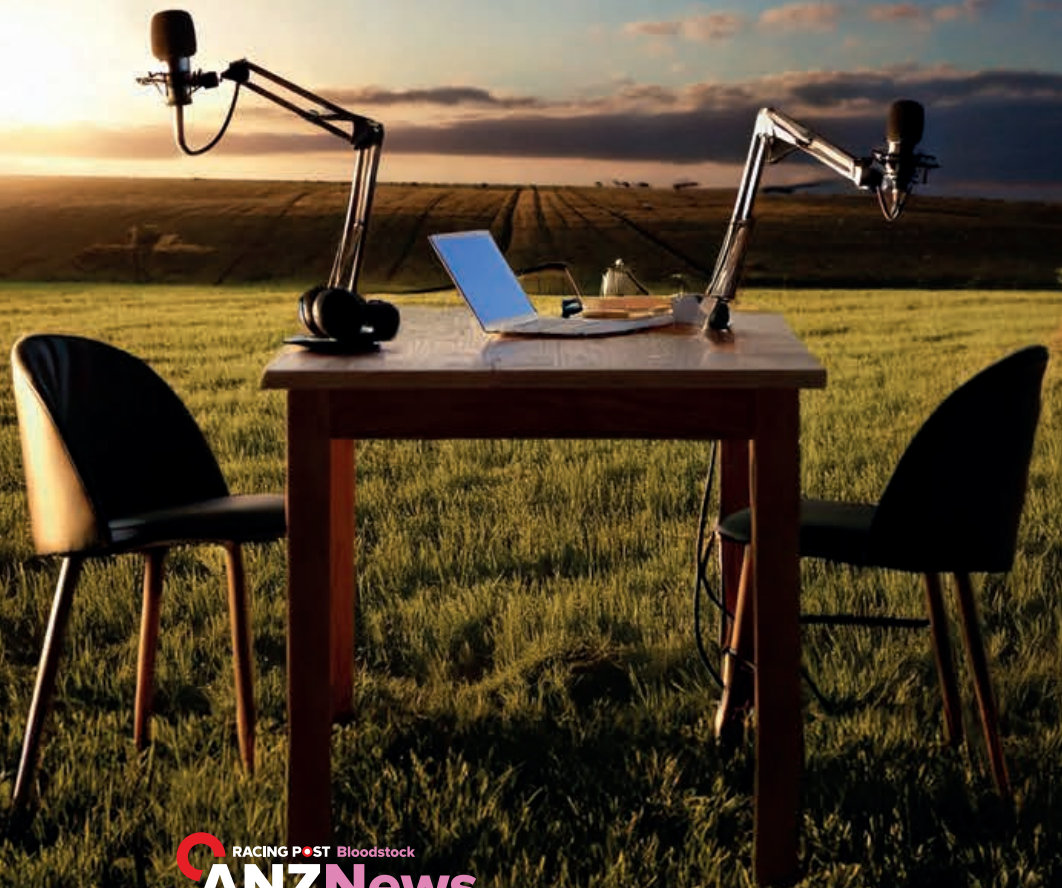

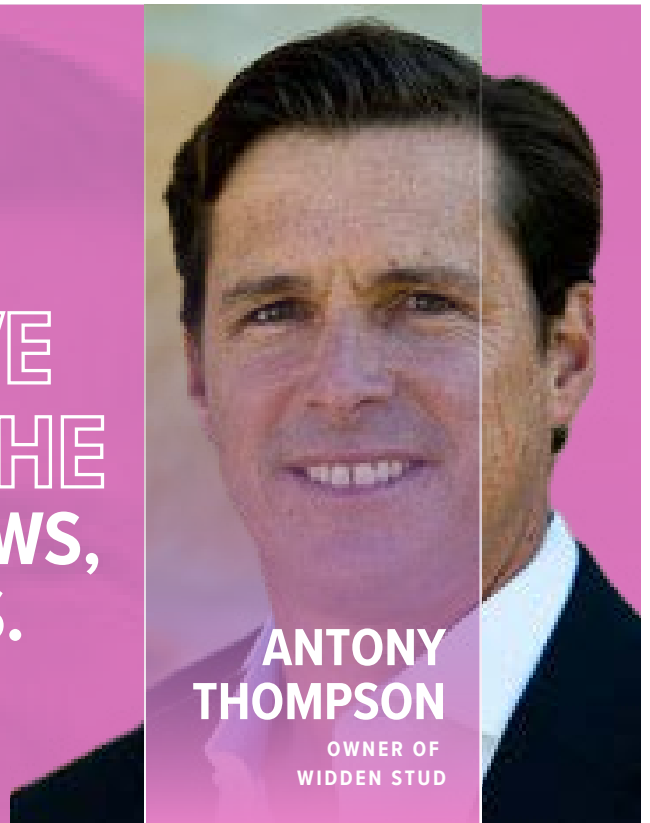
