Third Magic Millions 2YO Classic triumph for Maher as Unit Five makes history on the Gold Coast

The Unit Five connections celebrate the colt's impressive win

MAGIC MILLIONS

Ciaron Maher once again proved himself an exceptional trainer of juveniles when exciting colt Unit Five, a son of Widden Stud sire Supido (Sebring), claimed Saturday's Magic Millions 2YO Classic (RL, 1200m) at the Gold Coast, becoming the first horse to land the race on only his second start.

Bought by Maher for a mere \$80,000 at last year's Gold Coast Yearling Sale, Unit Five went into the \$3m scamper after only one previous race - a debut 2.5-length win in Caulfield's Magic Millions 2YO Classic (1100m) on December 20.

Such a light preparation was unprecedented for a winner of the Gold Coast's two-year-old highlight but Unit Five - who won a tune-up barrier trial at the Gold Coast 12 days before Saturday - validated Maher's judgment in emphatic style.

Unit Five was expertly ridden by renaissance jockey Thomas Stockdale, jumping from gate seven in a field reduced to 13 by three scratchings - including the race morning vet-enforced withdrawal of favourite Warwoven (Sword Of State) due to lameness.

Stockdale eased his mount back to settle fourth-last on the fence as an even tempo was set up front by Itchintogo (Sun City). **Cont. on page 2**

Continued from page 1 Entering the straight, Stockdale followed stablemate and \$4.40 second favourite Tornado Valley (Too Darn Hot) and his rider Ethan Brown as they made a move two horses off the fence.

But when switched into ample room on the inside, Unit Five burst powerfully to the lead to have the race in his keeping at the 100m.

The bay sprinted home to score by 1.11 lengths as fellow colt Tornado Valley gave another glowing endorsement for the Maher touch by taking second.

The Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott team's third-stringer from a three-horse contingent, filly By Choice (Written By), was 0.03 lengths further back in third at \$11 ahead of \$61 outsider Double Cool (Cool Aza Beel).

Tulloch Lodge's other two runners Knightsbridge (Farnan) and Shiki (Too Darn Hot) were fifth and seventh at \$11 and \$6.50 respectively, while \$3.30 favourite Zip Lock (Hellbent) split that pair.

It was an emotional Maher who spoke to the

media after his third win in the Magic Millions 2YO Classic in seven editions, following the successes of Away Game (Snitzel) in 2020 and Coolangatta (Written Tycoon) in 2022.

While Tornado Valley was having his fourth start and Unit Five his second, mega trainer Maher agreed the key to individually training two-year-olds was "not giving them too much [work] but just enough".

"That's the trick. They're not conditioned to racing much," he said.

"Myself and the whole team were quite confident that Unit Five, after one start, we were going to bring him up, give him a look at the track, trial this way around, and go in fresh.

"You want them still improving rather than getting there and not being able to do it.

"I was pretty confident with both of our runners. I was leaning towards the other one, to be honest."

Maher, who has 579 named horses on his books spread over nine locations - plus "a heap" more bought at the Magic Millions Yearling Sale

in the past week - paid tribute to his staff and especially his brother Declan, who now trains his own small team at the Gold Coast and helped prepare Unit Five for Saturday.

"Brother Dec put a lot of work into Unit Five, to get him here, and present and race like that at his second start. I don't think that's ever been done before [in the Gold Coast 2YO Classic]. It's awesome," Maher said. **Continued on page 3**

“I can say ‘I’ve done it again,’ but when you’ve got a large business it all comes down to your staff. And Dec. Awesome.”

He added: “Tommy Stockdale is a little ripper. He does a lot of work for us. Tommy’s starting to get into a habit of winning big races.

“He and Brown [Ethan Brown, rider of the runner-up] are good, hard-working blokes with good ability. I like working with people like that.”

Stockdale said he was confident before the race despite Unit Five’s light lead-up, having ridden him in his Gold Coast trial.

“I thought this guy’s trial was something to be reckoned with, and I shut him down early because he was going to show them up too much and possibly do too much,” he said. “I couldn’t wait to get up here today and see him today.

“[In the race] I was on the back of the right horses and I had to pick which one was right to take me in.

“For a young horse to go back to the rail by themselves and then to put them away shows how mature he is, and he’s a two-year-old to be reckoned with in the autumn.”

The 26-year-old Stockdale, who’s yet to win beyond Group 3 level but took Pakenham’s \$1m Supernova (1400m) on the Maher-trained Warnie (Highland Reel) last month, was also emotional after the victory, offering thanks to his wife Lily - who’s heavily pregnant with the couple’s first child - and to Maher for their support.

“The last month-and-a-half has just been unreal,” he said. “I sound like a broken record but Ciaron’s support has just changed my

career.

“I’ve always wanted to be competing on the biggest stages and riding in the biggest races but my weight has held me back from that, but I’ve always stuck to my work.

“I don’t know if he [Maher] realises what his support means.”

He added: “My wife

has seen the best of me and the worst of me through this game. With Ciaron’s support it’s only made me a better rider, and through the support of my wife, she’s just made me a better man. I can’t wait to get home and give her a hug.”

There is emotion, too, in the name of the colt.

Unit Five was bred by Widden’s stud manager Ben Walsh, nominations manager Matt Comerford, yearling manager Liam Attwood, financial manager Andrew Swales, and former team member Jarrod Robinson. The group bought the colt’s dam En Aval (Toorak Toff) via Magic Millions online for only \$9,500 in 2021.

With his breeders staying in the ownership when Unit Five was sold out of Widden’s Gold Coast draft last year, the colt is named after long-serving Widden staff member David Merrick, who died last February, and whose call sign on the stud’s two-way radio system was “unit five”.

The result was a timely one for Supido. Unit

Five is his third stakes winner after dual black-type victor Buenos Noches and Flemington Listed winner What You Need.

Supido has 97 winners from 150 runners and stood for \$9,900 (inc GST) last spring, down from \$16,500 (inc GST).

The win by Unit Five was the second winner on the Gold Coast card for a two-year-old out of a daughter of Toorak Toff (Show A Heart), after filly Toorak Jewel (Tassort), a daughter of Toorak Rose, took the \$500,000 The Debut (1000m).

Unit Five is the second foal of En Aval, who won twice. The mare’s colt by Anders (Not A Single Doubt) will be offered as part of the Widden draft at the Inglis Premier Yearling Sale in March. The youngster is catalogued as Lot 34.

En Aval now has a filly foal by Exceedance (Exceed And Excel) and was covered by Schwarz (Zoustar) last spring.

Tigroni (Tiger Of Malay) finished ninth in the 2YO Classic but won the lion’s share of the Magic Millions Racing Women’s Bonus, banking \$333,334 for her all-female ownership group.

Torque To Be Sure survives protest in Magic Millions 3YO Guineas

Torque To Be Sure (Shamus Award) broke his maiden with a welcome feature race win for his Rosemont Stud sire in a dramatic victory in Saturday's Magic Millions 3YO Guineas (RL, 1400m), surviving a protest to beat hot favourite Ninja (Farnan).

The race became an intriguing study between the Matt Dunn trained \$13 shot Torque To Be Sure - who entered the contest winless after ten starts - and \$1.60 hotpot Ninja, Michael Freedman's burgeoning star who'd won three of five.

With Torque To Be Sure and Ben Melham starting from gate 15 of 17, and Ninja from the widest gate, the latter followed the former in a three-wide line just worse than midfield.

Torque To Be Sure took the lead at the 200 metres as Ninja came after him to his outside. Melham's mount lurched outwards under pressure and impeded his rival's progress, before shooting away to score by 0.76 lengths.

Ninja's rider Tommy Berry fired in a protest and alleged the interference had cost him more than the winning margin. But chief steward Josh Adams said his panel found that while the level of interference was "significant", they could not be satisfied it would have made the difference

between winning and losing considering the margin.

The protest drama cut the post-race comments from the winning trainer and jockey to a minimum. But Melham was able to report Torque To Be Sure had considerable ability, despite his maiden status before Saturday which came alongside five placings, four of them in city class.

"He's not an easy horse to ride," Melham said of the gelding, who was a 0.31-length second last Saturday in the Sunlight Consolation (1100m).

"He went off the track a little but he was pretty good today. I ended up in a sweet spot and the back-up really helped me over 1400 metres.

"He was pretty dominant. Not a bad effort for a maidener. The ability was never the issue, but it is good to see him break through in this race today."

Thanking Torque To Be Sure's owners for their patience, Dunn said starting him over 1100 metres eight days earlier had helped him settle for Saturday's 1400-metre assignment.

"He's been a frustration," the Murwillumbah trainer said. "I'm lucky I've got a very patient owner's group in him. But when you look at what he did today, he's certainly always had the talent.

"The sky's the limit for him. Who knows what he can do.

"It was always the plan to go to the 1100 metres last week. Ben rode him perfectly today."

Bought by Dunn and Neil Jenkinson for \$260,000 from Attunga Stud's draft at the Gold Coast in 2024, Torque To Be Sure mixed some handy unplaced runs with his placings en route to Saturday's breakthrough.

At Brisbane's winter carnival last year, he was fifth in the Sires' Produce Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) before running a fair eighth in the JJ Atkins (Gr 1, 1600m).

Dunn said his confidence pre-race was "pretty high" because he'd felt Torque To Be Sure should have finished closer than two lengths behind Ninja two starts back, when the pair ran third and sixth respectively in the the Magic Millions Pierata Plate (1200m) at Doomben behind another imposing three-year-old in Grafterburners (Graff).

Coincidentally, Dunn said his horse had been hampered that day by interference from Ninja.

Asked what it was like to win a \$3m race, Dunn said it was "something else - especially when you've got a maiden going into it".

Reflecting on a long week after he'd bought five horses at the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale, Dunn said he was preparing to celebrate in unusual fashion.

"I'm ready to go to sleep," he said with a laugh. "It's a long week for trainers. I'm feeling the pinch."

Torque To Be Sure is the ninth foal of Elimbari (Fastnet Rock), who won one of her 13 starts, at Rosehill, and was Group 3-placed for trainer and co-breeder Kris Lees, who's also a co-breeder for Torque To Be Sure.

Elibari also produced Vincere Volare (I Am Invincible) and Conscious (So You Think), who are Group 2 and Listed-placed respectively.

The family, descendant from Listed-winning second dam Shalt Not (St Covet), also includes stakes winners Amelia's Dream (Redoute's Choice) and About Time (American Pharoah), and the Group 1-placed Young Werther (Tavistock).

Torque To Be Sure is the third stakes winner this season for Shamus Award (Snitzel), who covered 94 mares last spring at Rosemont for \$33,000 (inc GST), down from \$38,500 (inc GST).

Continued from page 4 The 15-year-old, who coincidentally broke his maiden in the Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m), now has 31 stakes winners, including six at the elite-level, from 527 runners overall at 5.7 per cent, and 330 winners.

Torque To Be Sure is the latest foal for Elimbari entered in the stud book.

Crash The Party finished fourth in the Guineas and, in addition to \$135,000 prize-money, picked up \$162,500 as the first of the horses eligible for the Magic Millions Racing Women Bonus past the post.

Tassort's Toorak Jewel shines in The Debut

Newgate Farm-based stallion Tassort (Brazen Beau) and young trainer Paul Shailer could have a ready-made star on their hands after Toorak Jewel showed up the boys in streaking away with Saturday's The Debut 2YO Plate (1000m) at the Gold Coast.

In the 11-strong field of first starters, bargain buy Toorak Jewel was sent out a slightly easy \$3 favourite after a scintillating 9.8-length win in her only barrier trial at the same track on December 30.

And, with champion jockey James McDonald securing the ride for her first start in Saturday's \$500,000 Debut, she emphatically lived up to that performance. Toorak Jewel was slightly wayward on jumping from gate two, but

soon mustered to the lead, led by two lengths around the turn, exploded to a five-length margin at the 250 metres, and won easing up by 1.44 lengths.

The filly's time of 56.31 was just 0.64 seconds outside the Gold Coast's overall track record for the 1000 metres - a fair effort for a juvenile debutant filly eased up near the post - especially considering that track record has stood for 22 years and McDonald rode a kilo overweight at 56kg.

Bred by Queensland's Lourdes Park Stud, Toorak Jewel was a \$36,000 purchase from Book 2 of last year's Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale for mega owner Mike Crooks, he of the "Mishani" squadron of runners.

She now looks destined to be a stable star for Shailer, who has some 62 horses on his books at his Gold Coast base, having spent 12 years with Chris Waller, including heading up the gargantuan trainer's operation at the same track.

That tenure came to an end when Shailer paid the price for a party at Waller's Gold Coast stable that infamously got out of hand in 2021, but he has been building his solo operation impressively in the past couple of years and, with Toorak Jewel showing abundant potential, his immediate future looks rosy.

Saturday's victory will also be welcomed by the team behind Tassort, who stands at Newgate for \$38,500 (inc GST) in a partnership with his owners, Emirates Park.

The nine-year-old stallion began with a bang in season 2023-24, with his first crop hatching two stakes winners including ATC Sires' Produce Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) queen Manaal and Group 2 victor Ameena.

While Tassort's second crop has yet to provide him with a third black-type victor, he now appears to have another star filly to his name, as Shailer reflected post-race.

"He [McDonald] had to go early in the race to cross the horse that kicked up inside her. She sustained a strong gallop but when James asked her to quicken she responded really nicely and looked like a filly with a fair bit of talent," Shailer said.

"Not going to get carried away as, obviously, they're all first starters but certainly had respect for the race with Gai [Waterhouse] and Adrian [Bott] having runners.

"It is a big thrill. She has shown us a bit and it was good to get the job done."

McDonald paid tribute to the filly - and his fellow expat New Zealander Shailer.

"Paul was always going to be a very good trainer," he said. "It was special. That is a good indication on what he can do.

"For her to be so quiet but to jump and run like she does. If she can harness that a bit then they're going to have a ball."

Crooks said he'd been led to buy the filly out of his respect for Tassort.

"I love the sire and I was happy to take it at the last minute. It's gone to Paul and he has done a great job," said Crooks, who despite having made millions from his swimming pools business, still likes to operate at the bargain end of yearling sales.

"I always have a bit of a budget and it is really low," he said with a laugh.

The Debut provided an all-female trifecta, with Waterhouse and Bott's Lady Moscato (Home Affairs) - a daughter of dual Group winner Champagne Cuddles (Not A Single Doubt) - second at \$6, and the Tony Gollan-trained Dolly Boom (Spirit Of Boom) third at \$8.

In fact, the first male home was Chris Anderson's gelding Tengun Tommy (Flying Artie) in sixth place at \$11.

Toorak Jewel hails from humble origins, with her yearling sale page having room for five dams.

Fifth dam Forina (Vibrant) won the fourth edition of the Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) in 1974, and her Listed-winning daughter Biscarina (Biscay) was the dam of four-time elite winning sprinter Schillaci (Salieri).

The last entry in the stud book for Toorak Rose comes through the birth of her filly by The Odyssey (Better Than Ready) in 2024.

Poster Girl brings up the Magic Millions double

A switch back to shorter trips has led to a bumper summer for Poster Girl (Alabama Express), the Chris and Corey Munce-trained mare who claimed her second feature in eight days at the Gold Coast on Saturday.

After taking last weekend's \$250,000 Rising Stars 3YO & 4YO feature over 1300 metres for fillies and mares by 0.45 lengths, Poster Girl backed up on Saturday to scramble home in the \$1m Magic Millions Fillies & Mares over the same trip.

Backed late to start at \$7.50, Poster Girl was impressive in doing it the hard way in what developed into a two-horse war from a long way out.

She crossed from gate 12 of 18 for Martin Harley to sit outside the leader, the Lucy Yeomans trained \$4.80 favourite Jenni The Fox (Too Darn Hot), who had the advantage of barrier two.

The pair were in front on settling and were able to dictate a moderate pace. Let loose on straightening, they then fought an epic battle down the straight. Jenni The Fox looked beaten at the 200m but fought back tenaciously on the inside to force Poster Girl to dig deep as the two hit the line locked together, with Poster Girl prevailing by 0.02 lengths.

The John O'Shea and Tom Charlton-trained Countyourblessings (I Am Invincible) had loomed on the first pair's inside near home but had to settle for third, 0.15 off the leader, at \$21.

Group-placed via her second in Storm Boy's (Justify) BJ McLachlan Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) in 2023, Poster Girl has now

won six of her 17 starts and four of her past five - two over 1200 metres and two over 1300 metres.

A \$160,000 Magic Millions Gold Coast purchase for senior owner Gerard O'Toole and Arthur Hoyeau, Poster Girl has added \$718,000 to her coffers in the past eight days, her earnings having soared past \$1.3m.

The four-year-old's career surge has come after her father-son training team was moved to rethink her distance targets, following an ignominious end to her last campaign with a ninth in Doomben's The Roses (Gr 2, 2000m) and a 14th in the Queensland Oaks (Gr 1, 2200m).

"Gee she was tough. She fought back and she was a sitting duck there for a while but she's done nothing but improve this preparation. She is best kept fresh over the shorter trips," Corey Munce said.

"The way the race was going to work out, we probably needed to be closer today from the draw. I didn't expect him to be outside the lead but he [Harley] had a pretty nice time there."

Chris Munce added: "The thing about this mare is that we tried to train her as a stayer last time and I think she runs a strong mile but I think she got hampered by wet tracks which she

hates. A firm track like today suits her."

Harley was equally impressed with Poster Girl's fight, especially having raced on successive Saturdays.

"I wasn't sure if I held on or not," he said. "With the week back-up, she's got the heart of a lion and she got up when it mattered."

Bred by Yulong and sold through their draft at Magic Millions Gold Coast in 2023, Poster Girl is the fifth foal of the unraced American-bred mare Caricature (Dubawi).

Her second dam, Brattothecore (Katahuala County), was a dual Listed winner and dam of another two-time stakes victor in City Style (City Zip), who won a Group 3 in England, a Listed in the US, and was thrice Group 1-placed in Dubai.

Caricature now has a colt by Grunt (O'Reilly) who is entered for the Inglis Premier Yearling Sale in March (Lot 544), a foal sister to Poster Girl, and was covered by Yulong's new sire Growing Empire (Zoustar) in November.

Alabama Express (Redoute's Choice), the nine-year-old who stood at Yulong for \$66,000 last spring, up from \$55,000 (inc GST), has four stakes winners from 116 runners, and 63 winners overall.

Widden Stud's first-season sire Portland Sky (Deep Field) registered his first winner on Saturday when Daryte (2 f ex I'm In Love by Fastnet Rock) scored on debut in the Magic Millions Plate (1000m) at Ascot. Ridden by William Pike for trainer Trevor Andrews, the filly put away the field by 3.1 lengths, with Farnova (Farnan) second and Perfume Princess (King's Legacy) another half-length back in third. A \$55,000 Magic Millions Perth Yearling Sale purchase for Mulcaster Bloodstock, Daryte was bred by Pepper Tree Farm Bloodstock and is the second winner from two to race out of Fastnet Rock (Danahill) mare I'm In Love, herself a half-sister to US stakes winner Scrumdiddlyumptious (Roman Ruler). Portland Sky stood the 2025 breeding season at an opening fee of \$16,500 (inc GST).

Three for Supido

Elibari is also the dam of Vincere Volare (I Am Invincible) and Conscious (So You Think), who are Group 2 and Listed-placed respectively. Torque To Be Sure is the third stakes winner this season for Shamus Award (Snitzel), who covered 94 mares last spring at Rosemont for \$33,000 (inc GST), down from \$38,500 (inc GST).

Melanite races away with the Magic Millions maiden plate

Ethan Brown made an immediate impression on trainer John Thompson after steering the progressive Melanite (Dirty Work) to victory in the \$250,000 Magic Millions Maiden Plate (1100m) at the Gold Coast on Saturday. Brown produced a polished ride aboard the lightly-raced son of Dirty Work (Written Tycoon), another that stands at Widden Stud, working across from barrier nine before unleashing a decisive sprint in the straight. Melanite exploded clear at the top of the lane and was eased down to score by 0.9 lengths over \$51 outsider Splash Of Steel (Winning Rupert).

He was traveling a long way from home, he was confident around the corner and the others were off the bridle while he was still traveling and he gave a good kick. He's a nice horse, he's always shown that ability but he's just been a bit unlucky. There are some great owners in the horse, they are great supporters and I'm very happy to get a win for them." Melanite was purchased for \$140,000 by Thompson and Boomer Bloodstock from the Fernrigg Farm draft at the 2024 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale.

Axius takes the Magic Millions Snippets

Justify (Scat Daddy) gelding Axius stamped himself as an emerging force in the sprinting ranks with a decisive victory for Ciaran Maher, Tim Clark and Dynamic Syndications in Saturday's \$1 million Magic Millions Snippets (1200m) at the Gold Coast. The four-year-old has been a gradual improver since debuting late in his juvenile season and delivered a breakthrough performance in the lucrative feature. Axius travelled strongly approaching the home turn and once balanced up in the straight, burst through a narrow gap and asserted late to score by 0.7 lengths over Payline (Shooting To Win) with stablemate Scampi (Blue Point) another 1.3 lengths back in third. Maher said the decision to back-up after Axius' placing in the Magic Millions Rising Stars Plate (1300m) had been rewarded. "The back-up has been working pretty well today," Maher said. "Dynamic are a good crew so it's fantastic to win a big one for them. He's a bit of a brute, he takes a bit of handling so [the team] have done a great job." Axius was bought for \$200,000 from Coolmore's draft at the 2023 Magic

King Of Roseau reigns in the Magic Millions Cup

King Of Roseau (4 g Capitalist ex Dominica by Choisir) relished the step back up to 1400 metres in Saturday's Magic Millions Cup (RL, 1400m), producing a rapid late surge to claim the \$2 million race by a narrow margin over Boomtown Boss (Spirit Of Boom).

The Peter Snowden-trained gelding was a good winner of the Aurie's Star Handicap (Gr 3, 1200m) last August and after a break had been building towards the Cup with good efforts over 1200 metres, including last time out when fourth in the Canterbury Sprint (Listed, 1200m).

The \$95,000 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale purchase needed every part of the extra 200 metres to reel in eventual third placegetter Moravia (Snitzel), with Boomtown Boss making his run alongside the winner and going down by 0.1 lengths.

Saturday marked a decade since Snowden saddled King Of Roseau's sire, Capitalist (Written Tycoon), to win the Magic Millions 2YO Classic. Snowden cut an emotional figure at the track and said

it was a deserved win for a large group of everyday Australians within the four-year-old's ownership group.

"It's a super day," Snowden said. "It's fantastic to see him win and win a race worth this sort of money.

"There wasn't much between five horses in the last 200m but he was tough. He's been working towards a peak performance and he did today.

"It's good to have nice horses. You never get tired of this [winning feeling] and when you do you should probably give it away."

King Of Roseau was bought by Pulse Racing Thoroughbreds and Pinhook Bloodstock International from the Ashleigh Thoroughbreds draft for \$95,000 at the Magic Millions Gold Coast. The gelding is out of Dominica (Choisir), herself a daughter of Coolmore Classic (Gr 1, 1500m) winner Danni Martine (Danzero).

The four-year-old was winning a stakes race for the second time having taken out Aurie's Star Handicap (Gr 3, 1200m) last August.

Snowden bought six yearlings in Book 1 at the 2026 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sales, including two fillies by Capitalist.

Ciaron Maher's treble at the Gold Coast also included Snitzanova (Snitzel), who proved too good for his rivals in the \$1 million Queensland Magic Millions Subzero (2200m). A Group 2 winner over 1600 metres at three, the Snitzel (Redoute's Choice) mare was stepping beyond 1800 metres for the first time but relished the extended journey. Zac Lloyd produced a polished ride from barrier 13, settling Snitzanova in behind Group 1 winner and second favourite You Wahng (So You Think) before running her down inside the final 200 metres to win by 1.3 lengths. Miss Joelene (Russian Revolution), last Saturday's Magic Millions The Wave (1800m) winner, closed late to finish third, another 1.2 lengths behind. Snitzanova was purchased for \$200,000 by syndicator Nathan Bennett at the 2023 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale, and Maher said it was a pleasure to again combine with Bennett Racing in a lucrative feature. "That was beautiful," Maher said. "I was a bit worried about how the race was going to unfold because she can get on the bit and she pulled over 1800 metres last week. But she was a bit unlucky and monstered the line the other day. Zac gave her a beautiful ride and with that decent tempo, it was like mile pace so she actually dropped her head and relaxed. Bennett Racing are very good at picking their horses - Nath, Phil, Rick and their team do it very well."

Sir Carter prevails in the Magic Millions Country Cup

The ownership group known as Mug Racing clearly made a shrewd investment in Sir Carter (Zoustar), whose earnings surged following victory in Saturday's \$500,000 Magic Millions Country Cup (1200m). Scenes of mourning yard jubilation followed a thrilling finish as the son of Zoustar (Northern Meteor) clung on for the narrowest of victories under Zac Lloyd, holding off late challenges from Astra Star (Cosmic Force) and Oberoi Princess (Dracarys). Just 0.3 lengths separated the first three across the line. Trainer Will Hulbert said the result was the culmination of a long-term plan for the gelding, who was initially purchased for \$100,000 by Grey Skies Bloodstock at the 2021 Magic Millions Gold Coast March Yearling Sale before selling to his trainer for \$17,000 via Inglis Digital a year later. "I thought he was home but then Kris' horse [Astra Star] came quickly and you always favour the outside horse here," Hulbert said. "But when the number was in the frame it was happy days. The 'Mugs' boys are bloody legends, they love racing and they love the horses. It's probably been a two-year plan with this horse because we were the first emergency in the race last year, so we've set it as our goal for the last 12 months. He got here today and did the job."

Wide barrier causes Hawker Hall no issues

James McDonald capitalised on a late call-up aboard Hawker Hall (Russian Revolution), producing a daring front-running display to land the \$250,000 Magic Millions Class 6 Plate (1200m) at the Gold Coast on Saturday. With Jason Collett sidelined after a fall earlier in the program, McDonald was drafted in by trainer Kris Lees and made an immediate impact. Jumping from a wide draw, the son of Russian Revolution (Snitzel) was sent forward and established a decisive break at the top of the straight, powering clear to score by 1.9 lengths

over Roselyn's Star (Shalaa). "I rode him like Nature Strip," McDonald said. "I obviously picked up the ride through Jason unfortunately being injured. He gave me good advice about letting him gallop. Kris Lees is a champion, he's a great bloke and it's good to ride a winner for him." The winner was purchased for \$150,000 by Andrew Williams and Bevan Smith from The Chase's draft at the 2023 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale. Saturday's success took his record to five wins from 11 starts, with prize-money earnings approaching \$400,000. Lees said the four-year-old still has improvement to come. "It was a good controlled, front-running ride," Lees said. "He's that type, when he can rail around like that, he put a good gap on them at the top of the straight and he was going to be very hard to run down. He's still got a lot to learn and you can imagine that he's an aggressive horse at home. He's a handful but we're winning the battle."

Future History relishes the heavy to land January Cup

Considered a late scratching option after the track downgrade, the eight-year-old instead rewarded connections' decision to run by leading throughout under Nash Rawiller, holding off Touristic (Frankel) by 0.9 lengths, with favourite Imperialist (Churchill) finishing a further 1.8 lengths

Outspan stamps class at Rosehill

Godolphin two-year-old Outspan (Bivouac) rebounded from a modest debut to stamp himself as a colt of promise with a dominant victory in Saturday's opening race at Rosehill. The Michael Freedman-trained colt settled behind the speed in the 1100-metre event before proving too strong late, scoring by 1.3 lengths over Long Throw (Brave Smash), with Miss Chanel (Tagaloa) a further 0.5 lengths away in third. It was a step forward from his debut fifth placing behind Saturday's Magic Millions 2YO Classic (RL, 1200m) fifth placegetter Knightbridge (Farnan). "It was good to see, he came on a lot and Sam [Clipperton] got him into a perfect position behind the leader," stable representative Sophie Johnson said. "He settled well and was able to come up off heels and finish off strong. He was a bit wayward last start, but he seems to have put it all together." The win pushed Outspan's earnings beyond

Big Sky makes Blue Diamond statement

race, and then the acceleration was instant when he went for it and he really ran right past the line."

While the stable stopped short of ranking their Blue Diamond prospects, Big Sky and Cranbourne debut winner Guest House (Home Affairs) are likely to meet in the Blue Diamond Prelude (Gr 3, 1100m) (C&G) on February 7.

"We haven't matched them up," Kent Jnr said. "We don't let them off the bridle until race day, and all you can do is go and win like that. He's won very impressively but it's only going to get harder from here.

"If you didn't go to the 1100 [metre] Prelude, you'd go to the Chairman's Stakes [Gr 3, 1000m], but the 1100 metres is a nice stepping stone to the 1200 metres of a Blue Diamond."

Aroha Stone (El Roca) returned to winning form with a strong performance for trainer Nathan Doyle in Saturday's Thank You Noel Cuthbert Handicap (1500m) at Rosehill. Partnered by Regan Bayliss, the mare relished the Heavy 8 conditions to score by 0.7 lengths over favourite Changing Colours (The Autumn Sun), recording the fourth win of her career from 15 starts. Bayliss said the mare was well suited by the conditions after an unlucky run at Randwick two weeks earlier. "I really liked her today," Bayliss said. "I had no luck last start but she had a nice soft barrier today and with the rain about she's at her best. She's been going really well this preparation and it's good to get another win on the board. She always felt like the winner. I had a lovely run in transit and although I felt Changing Colours giving a tough contest inside the last 150 metres, to our mare's credit she dug deep and won well." Stable representative Grace Willoughby said confidence was high heading into the mare's third run this campaign following a fresh-up win at Newcastle. "She's very tough," Willoughby said. "We knew she'd run well and it was just a case of putting a line through her last start. She had won third-up before, so we

were pretty confident. I think this is going to be one of her best preparations. Last time in she just needed to go out and mature and she has done that this prep."

Cross Tasman scores again for the O'Shea-Charlton stable

The aptly named New Zealand-bred Cross Tasman (Super Seth) continued his rise through the grades with an authoritative victory in the TAB Handicap (1500m) at Rosehill on Saturday for the in-form training partnership of John O'Shea and Tom Charlton. The gelding brought up the fourth win of his career at his seventh start, settling one-out and one-back under Dylan Gibbons before producing a decisive turn of foot in the straight despite the Heavy 8 ground, accelerating clear to score by 3.3 lengths. Invader Zim (Invader) was second and Pippie Beach (Maurice) another 0.9 lengths back in third. "He never grabbed the bit at all when I would have liked," Gibbons said. "He was funny, he got into his spot and dipped and dived a bit. When I was having to encourage him through that I thought it might take away from his finish, but he might be pretty good. I got to the 300 metres and I thought it was going to be hard work but I had a cheeky look a long way out because I just felt him go into over-drive. I'm going to say it was an unpreferred surface and the way he blew them away late, I love the way he did it." Bred by Waikato Stud, Cross Tasman is out of versatile triple Group 1 winner Daffodil (No Excuse Needed), who died last month. "Off that win, you wouldn't rule out 2000m and even beyond," Gibbons said. "He just switches off and once I thought I was going to have to get into him, he just clicked into another gear." A half-brother to the winner by Noverre (Savabeel) will be offered by Waikato Stud at Book 1 of Karaka. He is catalogued as **Lot 371**.

Bella Montagna scores a metropolitan win in Sydney

Bella Montagna (Belardo) broke through for a deserved metropolitan victory in the Ranvet Handicap (2400m) at Rosehill on Saturday

for trainers Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott. Ridden patiently by Josh Parr, the four-year-old overcame a wide draw to settle midfield on the fence and travelled strongly on the rain-affected surface, asserting late to score by 1.6 lengths over Forbidden Riff (Casino Prince) with Bestower (Contributer) another 0.6 lengths back in third. The win continued a productive association between Parr and the Waterhouse and Bott stable, with the jockey now successful on his past three rides for the partnership. "It was a perfect setup today," Parr said. "I was filled with confidence by the stable this morning and 2400 metres on rain-affected ground, she was licking her lips. I ended up in a really good spot from a bad barrier and she travelled well and there were horses that were under pressure a long way from home. I could wait for the gaps to open before I asked for an effort. It was just a push-button easy ride." Bella Montagna was Parr's sole ride of the day after his remaining engagements were scratched due to the downgraded Heavy 8 conditions. Previously trained in New Zealand by Darryn and Briar Weatherley, the mare joined the Waterhouse and Bott stable as a maiden but had shown promise when runner-up in the Sir Patrick Hogan Stakes (Gr 2, 2000m). She now boasts two wins and four placings from 12 starts.

Merrigold proves stamina in Flemington mile win

John Sadler joked that 'trainer stubbornness' was the reason Merrigold (Gold Standard) hadn't been tested over 1600 metres prior to winning at Flemington on Saturday. Celsius Star (Zoustar) kept on for second, with Fission (Russian Revolution) another half-length away in third. Continuing a strong run of summer form, jockey Harry Bates was impressed by the mare's turn of foot. "It's probably fair to say that's one of the easiest winners I've had," he told Racing.com. "It was just jump out in a straight-line and let her rip. We had a light weight, so all I wanted to do was keep her in her rhythm. She was really good, it's really

good for the owners, and it's good to get another Saturday winner for Ciaron and his crew." A full-sister to Immortal Star will be offered out of the Shadow Hill Thoroughbreds draft at the Inglis Premier Yearling Sale as Lot 420.

Hopefully he can continue to build."

Supernima scores brave win at HQ

A sage ride by Michael Dee aided Supernima (Super Seth) to claim a gutsy victory in Saturday's Thank You Volunteers Trophy (1400m) at Flemington. The Peter Moody and Katherine Coleman-trained son of Super Seth (Dundeel) had a declared change of tactics with the intention to settle further back. Sporting the colours of Wylie Dalziel Roy Higgins Racing, the four-year-old gelding dug deep in the straight to defy Ndola (Justify) and Prancing Spirit (Sir Prancealot) as he notched his fourth win from 18 starts with a further eight placings. "We had a bit of a theory in place today," Coleman told Racing.com. "We thought he was better when he was ridden a little bit colder and we weren't 100 per cent sure on the 1400 metres. But he's put pay to both of those questions today and it was a great ride from Mick. We'd worded him up beforehand that we wanted to try and ride the horse a little bit colder and when it wasn't going to work out, instead of sitting back there in no man's land, he took the race into his own hands and elected to roll forward when there wasn't much pace on. It was the ride that won the race. It's always special to get a win in the Wylie Dalziel colours but this crew especially, they've been very patient. He's always promised to deliver them a nice Saturday city winner and to get it at Flemington it's extra special. He's very, very honest. James and Wellwood quinella Desert Gold Stakes

Roger James and Robert Wellwood were convinced they had a Classic filly on their hands in the shape of Fairy Dream and she proved the team right when leading home a quinella for the stable in Saturday's Desert Gold Stakes at Trentham.

Ridden by Masahiro Hashizume, the three-year-old filly stayed on well to beat stablemate Waimea Bay (Savabeel) by 0.1 lengths. Crimson Sky (Ocean Park) finished a further 0.4 lengths back in third.

Wellwood was thrilled by the performance of the stablemates, especially the winner who he had feared may not be at her best on the Soft6 track surface.

"She (Fairy Dream) had a little bit of a traffic issue and didn't get out until late, but it was a good effort," Wellwood said.

"She is a top-class filly and I do think with some more time and a better surface we are going to see her do some special things in the future.

"Even in her maiden win, she won on the bridle, and it was good to see her with the blinkers on today as she travelled a lot better and with some more time and 2000 metres you might see her sweet spot.

"Waimea Bay had a little setback in the spring but has come back nicely and won really well at her last start.

"For her to pick up some black-type is great as she is a well-bred Savabeel filly, owned by the Chittick family."

at Ellerslie on 21 February and the New Zealand Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) a fortnight later.

"It's hard to say where we will go with her although the Fillies' Classic (Gr 2, 2100m) at [Te Rapa on 7 February] may be next and then you may see her in both an Oaks and a Derby," Wellwood said.

"We will stick to the fillies path at this stage and the Oaks is just an hour-and-a-half up the road to Ellerslie this year, which makes it easier to head that way, but who knows and the way she has won today, she has opened a lot of doors."

Owned by Colin and Helen Litt, who also raced superstar mare Orchestral (Proisir), who was also trained by James and Wellwood, Fairy Dream was a NZ\$360,000 purchase from the Elsdon Park Book 1 draft at Karaka in 2024.

She is out of the stakes-placed Viscount mare Fairygem and is from an extended family that includes Captain Cook Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Penny Gem.

The victory earns her six points in the NZB Filly Of The Year series which is currently headed by Well Written (Written Tycoon) and Lollapalooza (El Roca) on 20 points apiece.

Rosso tunes up for Wellington Cup with Trentham Stakes success

Following his Trentham Stakes (Gr 3, 2100m), Rosso has firmed in as favourite for the Wellington Cup (Gr 2, 3200m) at the same track in a fortnight. "He is a beautiful stayer," said winning rider Daniel Stackhouse. "The Pitman team have done a fantastic job in getting him here in perfect order. He began well and the race shaped well for him. We made a mid-race move to get a little bit closer in the running, but he just travelled the whole way, he has got a beautiful momentum stride on him and we used that to our advantage and let the horse that we were following take us into the race. I asked him to extend late and he was able to do that." Stackhouse is confident the rise in trip for the Wellington Cup should pose no issues for Rosso. "It took me a while to pull him up so I think two miles won't worry him at all, he switched off great," he said. "He has ticked every box going forward into that race, I have just got to talk with Michael and the team about the weight, so we will have a little think about that [whether he returns to ride]." Pitman was delighted with the performance and is already looking ahead to the Wellington Cup. "He will be back in his own paddock tomorrow night, and we will be back here in two weeks," he said. "Bring on two miles, it will be great."

Group 2 honours for Doctor Askar

Expat Irish jockey Joe Doyle scored an emotional victory in front of his visiting parents at Trentham on Saturday when taking out the Thorndon Mile

(Gr 2, 1600m) aboard Doctor Askar (Derryn). The pair settled off the pace early and had just three runners behind them when turning for home, but Doyle guided his charge out wide where he was able to chase down Marotiri Molly (Per Incanto) to win by 0.1 lengths. "I got a good drag into it off Pitman's horse [Mystic Park]," Doyle said. "I usually ride him more forward, he doesn't have to be ridden like that. It wasn't really until the 200 metres that he really got down to it and I thought 'we are going to do this.' I'm really happy to get the result." Doyle was particularly rapt to get the victory in front of his parents. "What a super horse," he said. "My Mum and Dad are here today, so it was nice to ride a big winner in front of them. We are horse racing people to the bone and it means everything. I'm gutted that it's not a Group 1 still, but any big win on a Saturday is fantastic for super connections, and having Mum and Dad on-course just adds to it." Doyle was runner-up on the Joanne Moss-owned and trained gelding in the Phar Lap Trophy (Gr 3, 1600m) at Trentham a fortnight ago, and he was bemused by his \$10.90 winning odds. "He has been a very good horse to me," Doyle said. "He was difficult to get going last year, we got to the right side of him, he fired a warning shot on the last day [in the Phar Lap Trophy]. I don't know why he was so friendless on the TAB, we went into it with a fair bit of confidence and he proved us right." This was Doctor Askar's third at stakes level following his wins in the Easter Handicap (Gr 3, 1600m) and Flying Handicap (Listed, 1400m) last year.

Mayor Of Norwood defends Waikouaiti Cup title

Classy southern stayer Mayor Of Norwood (Ghibellines) strengthened his Wellington Cup (Gr 3, 3200m) credentials with a commanding victory under top weight in Saturday's Waikouaiti Cup (2200m) at Wingatui. The Brian and Shane Anderton-trained seven-year-old carried 61 kilograms to back-to-back wins in the race, confirming himself a genuine contender for the Group 3 3200-metre feature at Trentham later

this month. Despite conceding 7 kilograms to his nearest rival, Mayor Of Norwood travelled comfortably in midfield under Corey Campbell before improving around the home turn. Leader Noble Knight (Ghibellines) had skipped clear at that stage, but Mayor Of Norwood quickly reeled him in, surging past at the 200-metre mark and drawing away to score by a comfortable length. Shane Anderson said the performance was exactly what was required to justify the trip north. "He was pretty impressive with the big weight today in a good, strong run race which helped him out a lot," he said. "We knew he was very well, but if we are going to make the big trip up to Trentham he had to win like he did. Corey knows him well and it was a nice ride as he let him find his feet and get balanced around the home bend before asking for his best. He has a really good turn of foot as he has won over a mile twice before." TAB Bookmakers have shortened Mayor Of Norwood into \$10 for the Wellington Cup.

Former Darley shuttler Blue Point (Shamardal) registered his 28th individual stakes winner when Dubai Beach (5 m ex Fire Blaze by Dubawi) prevailed by a neck in Friday's Cape Verdi (Gr 2, 1600m) at Meydan. Ridden by Kieran Shoemark for trainer Saeed bin Suroor, the grey mare knuckled down in the final yards to just get the better of French raider Quid Pro Quo (Lance), while stablemate Dubai Treasure (Exceed And Excel) finished another neck behind in third. A homebred for Godolphin, Dubai Beach is one of five winners out of Dubawi (Dubai Millennium) mare Fire Blaze, herself out of Falmouth Stakes (Gr 1, 1m) winner Nahoodh (Clodovil), making her a half-sister to both Japanese Grade 2 scorer Etes Vous Prets (Too Darn Hot) and Listed winner Hawkesbury (Shamardal). Blue Point will stand the 2026 northern hemisphere breeding season at Kildangan Stud for an unchanged fee of €100,000 (approx. AU\$173,450).

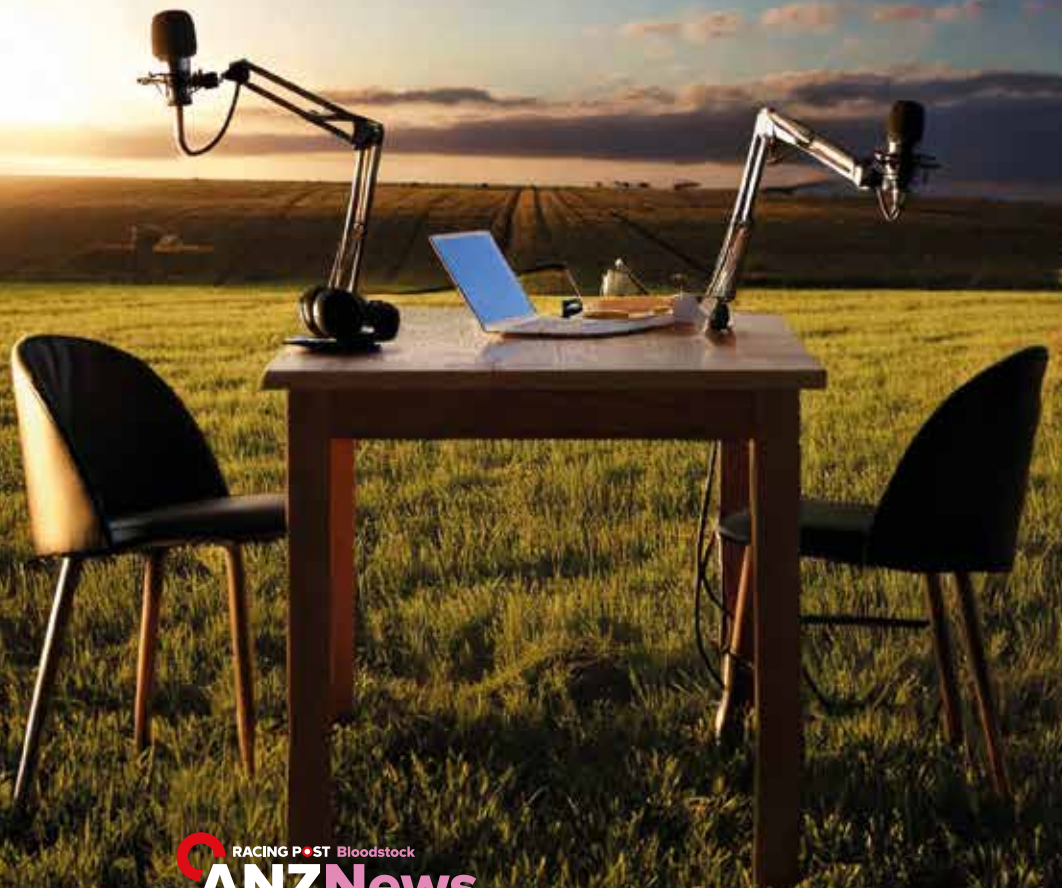
