

Extreme Choice filly takes a starring role on day one at the Classic sale

The rareness of Extreme Choice (Not A Single Doubt) stock, an enticing blend of grandfathers and an imposing physical form inspired Star Thoroughbreds and Vin Cox to land a surgical strike and secure the top lot on a fair first day at the Inglis Classic Yearling Sale.

While a torrid bidding duel had played out, Denise Martin's Star and Cox succeeded with a

single bid - \$425,000 - to emerge with the filly, offered by the home of subfertile sensation Extreme Choice, Newgate Farm, in partnership with Gooree.

The chestnut is the fourth foal out of Nais Ko, who is a daughter of a surging broodmare sire Exceed And Excel (Danehill). The mare is a winning half-sister to Group 1 victor Your Song (Fastnet Rock) whose page also includes Europe's Horse of the Year of 2001, Fantastic Light (Rahy).

Continued from page 2 One of just 44 live foals for the 2024 crop for Extreme Choice, the filly ranked as the top lot ahead of the \$400,000 colt by Hellbent (I Am Invincible) bought from Riverstone Lodge by BK Racing's Benny Vassallo who'll be sent to renowned two-year-old trainer Gary Portelli.

Day one of the sale yielded a mixed bag of results.

The clearance rate of 80 per cent eclipsed the 73 per cent figure at the close of day one last year, but the average was down 3.7 per cent at \$96,167. The median also dropped 6.25 per cent to \$75,000.

With 198 lots sold compared to 177 for 2025, the gross stood at \$19,041,000, a 7.6 per cent increase on the corresponding session 12 months ago.

Inglis bloodstock CEO Sebastian Hutch was optimistic the auction could still clearly outstrip last year's as trading continues, including on passed-in lots, but conceded selling had been tough for vendors in the sub-\$100,000 market.

"I'm pleased with the day," he said. "The metrics read well, the clearance is up significantly on the

equivalent stage of last year. The gross is up. The median is back a little bit, but that's consistent with the clearance being up.

"There's been a good bounce in it, certainly in terms of gross.

"You can prepare however you like, and I feel like we were well prepared for today, but you still can't make people put up their hand.

Continued from page 3 "So it was pleasing to see the sale start very well. There were some good results early, it was very strong through the middle of the day.

"But I don't think there's any disguising that in the sub-100 grand bracket, it feels very much like a buyers' market.

"Those horses cracking through six figures really seem to kick on, but it is a buyers' market in that less than \$100,000 bracket."

Hutch added: "I'd like it to be better than last year, and I think we've put ourselves on a good footing to do that, but I'd be reluctant to expect that to happen.

"With 270-lot days like today, you get a pretty fair spread of horses."

Ten yearlings sold for \$230,000 or more - identical to the completed figure for day one last year.

Top of the hill was Lot 233, one of three yearlings by Extreme Choice catalogued at the sale, who was swooped upon in dashing style by Martin and bloodstock agent Cox. Like all Star horses - including one of the sire's six Group 1 winners in another female, Espiona - the filly will be trained by Chris Waller.

"It was just the one bid," Cox said. "You judge the market as you will. We figured she'd be somewhere in the \$400,000 to \$500,000 range and were hoping there wasn't going to be anyone north of that."

Cox said aside from the precious shortage


of offspring of the sire, a large part of the allure stemmed from the grandsire and damsire.

"There were plenty of others going on her, but with Extreme Choice, it's just a case of 'You've got to get on, don't you?'" he said of the 12-year-old, who boasts a 12.24 per cent stakes winners to runners ratio.

"They're rare commodities, they have that scarcity value, and when you see a nice one, you've got to dig deep and put the seatbelt on and get into it."

"She's a lot like her sire and a lot like her grandsire in Not A Single Doubt. She's quite a strong, precocious looking filly, she's got a good head on her - she's sensible. She looks like she's one who's up and ready to go."

"The sire's done exceptionally well in the [Waller] stable, and Star's done very well with the breed as well, so let's hope the purple colours with the white stars come to the fore again."

He added: "She's typical of the breed, and the Not A Single Doubt breed as well."

"And being out of an Exceed And Excel mare - you can't get enough Exceed And Excel mares. They're flying at the moment."

"She's a glorious filly. Her pedigree's good, she's good physically, and just being by a sire that you can't get many of them, you've just got to get in."

Newgate stud manager Jim Carey was delighted with the outcome.

"It's a fantastic result and she was a lovely filly. We've always had success here at Classic in the past and she's a sharp, mature filly and we just thought it would be a good sale for her and it turned out that way," said Carey, whose farm will offer a colt by Extreme Choice as Lot 621 on Tuesday.

"I think we've run out of things to say about the stallion. It's common knowledge the amount of enquiries we're getting about him from all around the world from some of the biggest breeders in the world. It's a testament to the stallion and how good he is - he's a freak."

Sunday's second-top lot was a particularly fetching example of the progeny of Yarraman Park stallion Hellbent and the \$400,000 Vassallo paid for the colt made him the 13-year-old stallion's ninth most expensive yearling to date.

He's the fourth foal of the unraced Miramare (O'Reilly), whose two runners have had one unplaced run each. Despite that, a

pedigree point that will have pushed bidding north, given the large contingent of Asian buyers at the sale, is the fact Miramare is a sister to Group 1 winner Shamexpress, sire of Hong Kong phenomenon Ka Ying Rising.

Vassallo was thrilled with the purchase, having only led Portelli to first inspect the colt less than half an hour before he entered the ring.

"He's a lovely colt by a super stallion, Hellbent, who we've had a lot of success with," Vassallo said. "He's an early foal, and he's going to the right stable in that I think he'll be up and going early for Gary."

"Obviously, he can train any horse, but he's got a brilliance about him winning two Golden Slippers with about 40 or 50 horses in work, which I think is amazing."

"I believe he's a horse who profiles that he's going to get up and go early for us, so obviously he's very attractive to buyers. We didn't think it was going to be easy. To be honest, that [\$400,000] was going to bottom us right out, so thankfully they [rival bidders] didn't bid again."

Vassallo noted BK Racing had bought another smart Hellbent from Riverstone Lodge in the Brad Widdup-trained Savvy Hallie, winner of the Silver Shadow Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m).


His only horse with Portelli so far is Long Legs (Russian Revolution), a three-year-old filly with a Rosehill win and a Group 3 third from four starts so far.

"Benny said: 'I want to buy you a nice colt at Classic,'" Portelli said moments after the gavel fell. "He said, 'I'll see you at 2.30. I'll show you this colt.' Now it's three o'clock, and we've got the horse.

"We thought it was going to be tough to get him because we thought he could be a horse Hong Kong would go for. But Ben went hard and the rest is history. Hopefully they'll be rewarded now.

"He's an impressive type, a real powerful two-year-old type. He's by Hellbent, tough Australian stock, out of an O'Reilly mare. We've had a bit of luck with O'Reilly mares in our stable, so hopefully this one will work for us too."

Four lots shared third place on the price list, at \$300,000.

Arrowfield Stud's Lot 180 - a filly by The Autumn Sun (Redoute's Choice) out of unraced Irish mare Memphis (Dubawi) - went to the Byerley Bloodstock concern of Liam Peters, son of mega Perth owner and breeder Bob Peters.

Lot 246, Sledmere Stud's colt by Per Incanto (Street Cry) out of unraced New Zealand mare New Status Quo (Ocean Park), from the same family as Group 1 winners I Wish I Win (Savabeel) and Savy Yong Blonk (Savabeel), went to the Hong Kong Jockey Club.

Star stallion and Classic graduate Private Harry's (Harry Angel) half-brother by Zousain (Zoustar) - Lot 56 - was bought by Team Archibald and William Johnson Bloodstock from breeders Rheinwood Pastoral.

And while Private Harry's original owners Kurrinda Bloodstock didn't buy that colt - despite buying the past two half-siblings by Anders (Not A Single Doubt) and Capitavant (Capitalist) also at Classic - they were among the \$300,000 buyers on Monday after bidding in

partnership with Waterhouse-Bott and Kestrel Bloodstock. The triumvirate bought Lot 124, Monarch Stud's filly by Too Darn Hot (Dubawi) out of seven-time winner Lady Sioux (Jet Spur).

Rheinwood's Kirsty Willis was delighted to reap the same figure for the Zousain colt. That makes him the most expensive offspring of the mare Happy Pilgrim (Congrats), who's now back in foal to Harry Angel (Dark Angel).

"It's absolutely amazing - what a result for the entire team," Willis told ANZ.

"I'm just so grateful for our team, they've prepared the horse to perfection and he hasn't put a foot wrong all week."

"For me, he's the best horse the mare's thrown. He just oozes quality, he's got a great temperament, he's absolutely stunning."

"And I couldn't be happier he's gone to Rob and Annabel. They've tasted Group 1 success with one of our graduates in Libertad. Hopefully, this one will be adding to that Group 1 tally."

The Classic sale continues on Monday with the action set to get under way at 10am.



Kurrinda Bloodstock come out firing at Classic

Back at the sale where they struck gold when buying Private Harry (Harry Angel) three years ago, Kurrinda Bloodstock flexed its increased buying muscle with a pair of top shelf purchases at Inglis Classic on Monday.

Sean Driver's syndications group went hard for one that went early - Lot 15 - paying \$260,000 for New Zealand farm Windsor Park's colt by hot young stallion Sword Of State (Snitzel), in tandem with new partner Ciaron Maher.

Kurrinda then teamed with Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott and Kestrel Thoroughbreds, paying \$300,000 for Monarch Stud's Lot 124, a filly by Too Darn Hot (Dubawi) - sire of the Kurrinda-Tulloch Lodge stakes-winning two-year-old filly Shiki.

Driver bought Private Harry's half-sister last year with that stallion's trainer Nathan Doyle for \$220,000. In 2024, also at Classic, the same pairing bought a half-brother by Anders (Not A Single Doubt) for \$100,000.

On Monday, Driver didn't make it four siblings in the end when another half-brother by Zousain (Zoustar) came under the hammer. That colt went from breeders Rheinwood Pastoral to Team Archibald for \$300,000.

Still, done for the day with his two purchases, Driver reflected on the successes that have allowed Kurrinda to move up the budgetary ladder in recent times. This includes buying an I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit) colt at Magic Millions Gold Coast last month for \$480,000, again with Waterhouse and Bott and Kestrel, and going to \$420,000 for Shiki with the same trainers at that sale a year earlier.

And while Kurrinda enjoyed a windfall last March when Yulong bought half of Private Harry in a deal understood to be worth more than \$8 million after his win in The Galaxy (Gr 1, 1100m), Driver said that hadn't acted as any trigger towards greater spending.

"It's got nothing to do with Private Harry's sale - that's a completely separate issue," Driver told ANZ News. "It's just the way we've grown. We're very calculated."

"We paid \$115,000 for Private Harry three years ago. We were probably only getting up to the \$200,000 mark back then.

"But with time, you need to adjust. Things cost more. It's inflation, right? The horse world's the same."

Kurrinda, which prepares its new yearlings and spells its horses on its own 40-acre farm near Cessnock, has also been buoyed by a wave of non-Private Harry results in recent times.

Aside from Shiki, who's earned \$265,000 from two wins, Kurrinda's white with the pale blue star have been carried by Doyle's Roman Consul Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) hero Hidden Motive (Capitalist), Matt Dale's Caulfield stakes winner Boston Rocks (Hellbent) and his lightly-raced city-winning stablemate So You Pence (So You Think), among others.

"At the end of the day the results are there on the racetrack, so hopefully it continues," Driver said.

"We're also getting great support from our trainers. When we purchase a horse, the trainers are all staying in the horse, so they trust our systems. The horse spells with us, and it's educated by us, which is really good for us, because not only do we get to control the first part of their career but it shows the trainers have a lot of trust in us."

"So it [spending power] is just about the way we've grown.

"We've had a great year on the rack, whether it's been Hidden Motive or So You Pence, Boston Rocks, Private Harry and Shiki.

"It's across the board with different trainers. Those trainers want to be a part of that success. They're hungry, they've got the athlete mindset, and we want our horses to be in the best systems too, especially if you're spending that sort of money. It's going to give the horse every opportunity."

Kurrinda has grown its number of trainers. While the group started predominantly with Dale, and then added Doyle, it now also has horses with Waterhouse and Bott, David Pfeiffer, Richard and Will Freedman and Queensland's Stuart Kendrick.

And in a few weeks it will have its first horse in the Victorian stables of Australia's largest trainer numerically - Maher - in its Sword Of State colt.

"Ciaron's a big stable, he gets results nationwide, so I'm excited to be a part of it and I'm looking forward to seeing how that relationship evolves," Driver said.

"It's about relationships. You need to be able to work together - that's the key. Whether things are going well or bad, you need to work together."

"I expressed that I want this horse [Lot 15] to go through our system, so that horse will arrive at our farm tomorrow. Once the horses are in work with the trainers I don't interfere too much. I let them do their job."

"Now we've got seven trainers. As long as the horse is going to that right system, that's what it's about. When we purchase a horse, we know where that horse is going to."

"The key is - where would this horse succeed? For example, if a trainer is keen on a certain horse but I don't think the horse suits

their model, I'm not interested."

"And if we and the trainers are all keen on the same lot number, that's key. Obviously, we'll then go quite aggressively to get it."

While it's expanded its trainers list, Kurrinda is content to stay at its current size, with racing stock numbering in the 50s.

"We're pretty happy with the numbers we've got," Driver said. "We don't want to get too big. We're very hands-on at the farm. I'm there three or four days a week, our farm manager lives at the farm and my wife Genevieve does everything else behind the scenes."

"We want to just focus on quality over quantity."

Driver was enthusiastic about Maher's new Kurrinda colt, whose Cambridge Stud sire Sword Of State (Snitzel) has begun in strong style with a stakes victor among four winners from ten starters. His winners include Bjorn Baker's Warwoven, who's unbeaten in two starts.

"The colt just moved so well, and we've had success at this sale going on type," Driver said.

"To me, he was in the top three of the sale. I just loved the way he moved, carried himself, and he had a good attitude."

"Warwoven is arguably the most exciting two-year-old in the country. The stallion's doing a fantastic job, it [Windsor Park] is a great farm, so he ticked a lot of boxes."

Driver and Waterhouse and Bott will be hoping their new Lot 124 can emulate their strong start with their other Too Darn Hot filly.

"We've had the luck there with Shiki by the same sire, and this one just moves so well," he said. "Just the athleticism and how she carried herself was fantastic."

"As soon as we looked at her, we had her as the top filly at the sale. Biomechanically, she rated very highly and as a type she was right up there."

"She's bigger than Shiki, stronger as a yearling; she's probably already taller than Shiki. She's a lump of a filly for a Too Darn Hot, but she's definitely precocious - that's one similarity to Shiki."

21 for Starcraft

Blonde Star (5 m ex Blonde Mafia by Redoute's Choice) became the 21st individual stakes winner for late Rosemont Stud stallion Starcraft (Soviet Star) when landing Sunday's Hobart Cup (Gr 3, 2400m) at Hobart. Sent off a \$31 chance under Irish-born rider Erica Byrne Burke in what was her first career run in a stakes race, the five-year-old mare lunged at the line to get a 0.1 lengths verdict in the photo-finish over Ziryab (Kingman). There was a further 0.2 lengths back to Distrustful Award (Shamus Award) in third. Blonde Star is a half-sister to the Group 3-placed winner Titan Blinders (All Too Hard) and is the best of four winners out of the winning Redoute's Choice (Danehill) mare Blonde Mafia, herself a sibling to Group winners Danroad (Danheill), Strawberry Boy and stakes winners Newtown Jet (Prized) and Tippitaka (Red Ransom). Starcraft died in 2022.

Blonde Star team enjoy Hobart Cup success

Seven Mile Beach-based trainer Imogen Miller was delighted to land Sunday's Hobart Cup with Blonde Star, providing both the local trainer and jockey Erica Byrne Burke with their first victory at Group 3 level. "We knew she'd run well today. Things didn't really go our way

at Devonport, so it's probably been unlucky there," she said. "I thought her run was good last start, but maybe she wasn't at her best, and she pulled up and had a few little niggling issues in between runs, so really very happy obviously with her today. She's a ripping little horse and she's a beautiful horse to have around. She tries hard, she's consistent. I mean, can't really fault her. We all love her." Erica Byrne Burke was ecstatic with the win. Despite admitting she was not happy with her own ride. "I'm in disbelief. I didn't believe it until I came back and saw the number and everyone's cheering, but, yeah, I can't believe it," she said. "She was so good. I can probably say now I gave it a bad ride. I wanted to do this for Brendon and [Imogen], and all the owners, it's just great. I was just saying in my head, just don't hit the front too soon. It's a long way from home. But, God, she was gutsy. To win a Hobart Cup, it doesn't really feel real. For Brendon and Imogen to keep me on his horse, they've been very good and great supporters. I'm kind of lost for words, really. It's just brilliant."

First for Anders

Widden Stud's second-season sire Anders (Not A Single Doubt) chalked up his first stakes winner on Sunday when the John Blacker-trained Daytona Diva (3 f ex Step The Pedal by Elvstroem) produced a strong winning

performance in the Strutt Stakes (Listed, 2020m) at Hobart. Ridden by Jabez Johnstone, the three-year-old filly took up the lead 200 metres from home and cleared away from her rivals to score by 1.8 lengths over Aurora Rise (The Autumn Sun), who kept on well in the closing stages. There was a further three lengths back to Missy Aggravation (Kermadec) in third. Purchased for \$40,000 by her part-owner Tanya Hanson at the 2024 Magic Millions Tasmanian Yearling Sale, Daytona Diva was bred by Armidale Stud and is the best of three winners from as many to race out of the Group-placed Elvstroem (Danehill) mare Step The Pedal. Anders stood the 2025 breeding season for a fee of \$13,200 (inc GST).

Sanniya takes Group 3 honours in Hobart

The Barry Campbell-trained Sanniya (3 f ex Stratosphere - Lady Writer by Written Tycoon) secured her biggest victory to date when taking out Sunday's Mystic Journey Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) at Hobart. Ridden by Craig Newitt, the three-year-old filly made all in the colours of Star Thoroughbreds and cruised to an eased-down two-length success over Alvarinho (Tough Speed) with a further 1.5 lengths back to the third-placed Silver Dagger (D'Argento). Sunday's win took Sanniya's career record to six wins from just seven starts, with her only defeat coming when second in The Baker Group Cup (1200m) at Launceston in November.

Steparty gets back to winning ways

Multiple Group 1 placegetter Steparty (5 g Artie Schiller - Watch Your Step by Sepoy) registered his first victory since September, 2023 when scoring a narrow win in Sunday's Thomas Lyons Stakes (Listed, 1400m) at Hobart. The Paul Preusker-trained five-year-old was ridden by John Allen and came from the rear of the 11-runner field to stay on well and grab Durazzo (Needs Further) by 0.3 lengths at the line. There was a further 0.7 lengths back to Welwal (Shala) in third place. Placed in the 2023 Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m), 2024 Sir Rupert Clarke Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) and last year's CF Orr Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m), Steparty added to his wins in the 2023 Caulfield Guineas Prelude (Gr 3, 1400m) and McKenzie Stakes (Listed, 1200m).

Slipper still on the cards for Incognito

Michael Freedman has confirmed that Incognito (Stay Inside) will press on to next month's Golden Slipper (Gr 1, 1200m), despite disappointing when fifth in the Canterbury Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) on his return on January 31. Jockey Tommy Berry reported post-race that he

thought the colt suffered a palate displacement and Freedman confirmed subsequent vet examinations appeared to support that theory, but that it was a manageable one. "It can be displaced for a very short period of time then go back in place very quickly," Freedman said. "It's a bit of a frustrating one and they can do it once and never do it again. It's one of those racing things that can happen sometimes. Hopefully we can just make a few subtle changes because he is obviously a lot better than that. I was, to some degree, quite happy to find an issue. If you go home with no issues, you think maybe we're not good enough." Freedman revealed that Incognito would not be required to barrier trial again by Racing NSW stewards and will head for the Silver Slipper (Gr 2, 1100m) at Rosehill on February 21. "He's in good order so the plan will be to change a little bit of gear on him," Freedman said. "I'm not exactly sure what that will be, maybe a tongue tie and a different type of bit, and then go to the Silver Slipper, although if we decided we wanted to wait an extra week, we could. He will be here next Saturday, that's the plan. I'm very happy with him. He did a nice bit of work [Saturday] morning, and he will have a gallop on Tuesday."

Tentyris takes in Caulfield gallop

Coolmore Stud Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) hero Tentyris (Street Boss) took in a hitout between races at Caulfield on Saturday, pleasing trainers Anthony and Sam Freedman. The three-year-old is gearing up for a two-run campaign ahead of a potential trip overseas that could include Royal Ascot. The son of Street Boss (Street Cry) will tackle the Black Caviar Lightning Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m) on Saturday and will then head to Newmarket Handicap (Gr 1, 1200m) at Flemington on March 7. "He's been on track for an hour-and-twenty, he had a play around, a sweat, he's been stimulated," Freedman said. "It's been a big day for him and that will bring on his fitness as much as anything else, and he

will go back to Flemington that little bit more relaxed I would imagine. We took him for a couple of race day gallops last preparation, and it seemed to work well enough and hopefully it will take the edge off him for next week. The first two runs are pencilled in and then it's up in the air. He's got to come back in the Lightning and run very well, and if he was to win the Lightning, we would have to see what weight he gets in the Newmarket. There have been conversations around overseas, but it's all form dependant, how the horse is going, what's best for him. There's been no chat about a premature retirement or anything like that. If the horse is in form there is every chance he will race on into his four-year-old year, so there is the chance of travel then if he is going well."

Trelawney Stud principals Brent and Cherry Taylor thought she may be better placed in New Zealand and decided to bring her across the Tasman and entrusted her to the care of Matamata trainer Cody Cole last spring. She has been perfectly placed in her subsequent outings, contesting three MAAT races and she has brought home a winning cheque on each occasion. The daughter of Deep Field (Northern Meteor) was backing up just a week after her last start at Trentham and that was her connections only concern heading into Saturday, but she was able to hold off the late challenge of a luckless Sarti (Snitzel) by 0.1 lengths. "She was really tough," Cherry Taylor said. "I thought if she was going to get beaten it would have been today on a short back-up. He [Cole] has done an amazing job with her. She is a filly that is not easy. The Freedman boys did a great job with her [in Australia] but she really likes being trained out of the paddock, so it has been perfect to bring her back here and get those wins on the board as a broodmare in the future. She is going to the paddock now for a well-deserved spell and we will bring her back and hopefully get some black-type with her."

Dunedin Gold Cup plan for In Vegas

It may not have been by design, but Balcairn trainer Centaine Spittles got her hands back on the Gore Cup following In Vegas' (Telperion) win in the 2200-metre feature at Wingatui on Saturday. The seven-year-old daughter of Telperion (Street Cry) won the same race last year and Spittles didn't have any intention of her mare defending her crown, however, the race's transfer to Wingatui following Gore's abandonment last week opened up a window of opportunity. "We got a little bit lucky with them putting Gore off and transferring the Cup to Dunedin," Spittles said. "I was never backing her up after Marlborough, we were always

going to go to Dunedin. That [abandonment] gave us a second chance to have a crack at that Cup." In Vegas headed into the race in good form, having finished runner-up in the Kumara Gold Nuggets (1810m) and Marlborough Cup (2000m) last month, giving Spittles plenty of confidence heading south. From her outside barrier in the ten-horse field, In Vegas was taken back to settle at the rear of the field before jockey Akshay Balloo asked his charge to improve three-wide from the 800 metres. In Vegas loomed ominously at the turn and after balancing up she began to wear down the leaders, capturing the lead with 100 metres to go and dashed away to a 1.3 lengths victory over Generation Joy (Ghibellines). "I was pretty confident with her going down and she ran up to what I expected," Spittles said. "Akshay knows her really well. I thought she was pulling too hard in the running, but he got going right when he needed to."

That's Gold to take Avondale Guineas route

Progressive three-year-old That's Gold (Lucky Vega) never left the inside rail as he stormed home to collect his richest career win in the \$350,000 Sir Patrick Hogan Karapiro Classic (1600m) at Te Rapa on Saturday. The Chris Wood-prepared son of Lucky Vega (Lope De Vega) has tackled the best of his age group in his current preparation having taken out the Bonecrusher Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) three starts ago before finishing fifth in the Auckland Guineas (Gr 2, 1400m) and third behind New Zealand Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) contender Chilling Out (Savabeel) at his most recent performance. Bounced away quickly at the start by Sam Collett, That's Gold fended off the challenge of eventual runner-up Rambling On (Almanzor) to score by 0.2 lengths at the line. "I thought drawn [barrier] one he had to be hard to beat," Wood said. "I said to her [Collett] don't dig him up too much as he will get over-racing as we are trying to get him to settle as we head

towards those 2000 metres and more races. It's a huge, huge thrill and I'm over the moon. His work this week has been exceptional. He has a great syndicate of owners and I have to thank them, my staff at home who are incredible, and my farrier. I have a lot of good people around me who are a big help and it was also a lovely ride by Sam." Wood noted the horse would now head to the Avondale Guineas (Gr 2, 2200m) at Ellerslie on February 21 before contesting the New Zealand Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) a fortnight later.



Eight for Tivaci

Numbers (4 g ex Sheezababe by Zabeel) became the eighth individual stakes winner for Tivaci (High Chaparral) when landing Sunday's Centenary Vase (Gr 3, 1800m) at Sha Tin. Numbers was a \$50,000 NZB Ready to Run purchase from Ohukia Lodge for his previous co-trainer John O'Shea. He is a half-brother to the Group 1-placed winner Impecunious (Sacred Falls) being out of the stakes-placed Zabeel (Sir Tristram) mare Sheezababe, herself a daughter of Sydney Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) winner Honor Babe (Honor Grades).

HK: Brown scores Hong Kong licence

Leading Melbourne jockey Ethan Brown has accepted an offer to ride in Hong Kong from April 20 through until the end of the current season. The 26-year-old, who currently sits third on Melbourne Jockeys' premiership with 27 winners, will be eligible for rides in Hong Kong from April 26. "It's a good opportunity and I'm ready for a new challenge," Brown said. "Terry Bailey [former Melbourne chief steward] rang me a couple of weeks ago and asked if I would be interested and, I said 'definitely', and it all got ticked off in the last few days. It's always been in the back of my mind to go there, and when they offered, I didn't have

"The Hong Kong trip is all based around Jimmy," Brown said. "He'll run in the All-Aged on the 18th, I believe, and then I'll fly out on the 20th and spend three-and-a-bit months there."


189 for Into Mischief

Numbers emerges as Classic Series force after Centenary Vase romp

Numbers (Tivaci) firmly advanced his credentials for the remainder of the Hong Kong Four-Year-Old Classic Series with a commanding victory in Sunday's Centenary Vase Handicap (Gr 3, 1800m) at Sha Tin.

The Frankie Lor-trained gelding dominated his six rivals, each with a Group-level winning profile, as he led from start-to-finish on his way to a two-length victory in the HK\$4.2 million (approx. AU\$769,420) contest.

The Tivaci (High Chaparral) gelding went off a strong \$1.70 favourite on the strength of an eye-catching front-running victory in December, his first in Hong Kong. The handicapper gave him eight points for that, but Numbers still went off from the foot of the weights against a more experienced field.

From barrier two, he was worked to the head of the field by Derek Leung and enjoyed a rail-hugging passage half-a-length in front of Andrea Atzeni on Ensued (Lemon Drop Kid) to the bend. As they entered the straight, a group headed by Chancheng Glory (Mor Spirit) under Zac Purton moved to his shoulder to briefly offer resistance, before Leung shook up the four-year-old and opened a gap on his pursuers. Speed Dragon (Darci Brahma), ridden by Lyle Hewitson, improved to take second, with Karis Teetan and Encountered (Churchill) finishing third.

"He was still a bit nervous in the gates, but he did a good job," Leung said. "He handled himself pretty good. After he relaxed, I started to pick up at the 800 metres. He listened to me, and he made my job pretty easy."

Leung said his tactical versatility makes Numbers a major threat for the Hong Kong Derby (2000m) on March 22.

"He can lead, or if someone's going faster than him, he can be second or third – just whatever he wants to be," Leung said. "He loves to chase a horse. So, it doesn't matter ... he loves

the challenge."

The second leg of the Four-Year-Old Classic Series is the Hong Kong Classic Cup (1800m) on March 1, and on this evidence, Numbers will take some beating as the Series extends to 1800 metres and beyond. His last act in Australia pre-import was a spirited second in the Queensland Derby (Gr 1, 2400m). Trainer Lor said he was confident.

"I have a lot of hope. You can see in Australia he already has form over 2400 metres, so I don't think there will be any problems and we'll just go for it," he said.

Andrea Atzeni improved to 25 wins for the season as he grabbed a treble. The Italian's first winner came on King Dance (Nyquist), who produced a giant effort to snatch his first career win at the seventh attempt. The US-bred chestnut, trained by Francis Lui, is a son of dirt superstar Nyquist (Uncle Mo) and made good on his classy pedigree, claiming the first section

of the Class 4 Lung Yat Handicap (1200m, dirt).

Atzeni made it two after a grinding effort on David Hall's Good Chap (Deep Field), who claimed a first career win in the second section of the Class 4 Lung Yat Handicap (1200m, dirt). Hall was especially pleased with the win, given the Deep Field (Northern Meteor) gelding's difficult start in Hong Kong.

"It wasn't a big surprise. He's always shown a bit of ability," said Hall.

"We've had a few soundness issues with him. I think with the breed – Deep Field – they certainly love the surface, and I think they love a set of blinkers. He trialled well with them, so he took his trial to the races."

Atzeni's treble was completed when he piloted John Size's four-year-old Flow Water Flow (Proisir) to victory in his first Class 3 run in the Yau Oi Handicap (1800m). The Proisir (Choisir) gelding has now recorded two wins after three seconds in his debut campaign.

Mark Newnham's Lucky Ranger (Vanbrugh) maintained his upward trajectory with a fine win in the first section of the Class 4 On Ting Handicap (1400m). In both of his first two starts, the three-year-old was forced to overcome the widest draw, but did so comfortably, delivering a 22nd win of the season for Luke Ferraris, and maintaining a one-win lead (35) for Newnham in the trainers' standings.

The Brett Crawford-Karis Teetan axis continued to fire as Island Buddy (Brave Smash) took the spoils in the Class 4 Yan Oi Tong Cup Handicap (1200m) with the Mauritian having now been aboard eight of Crawford's 14 victories since relocating to Sha Tin this season. The five-year-old has now won both races since his transfer to the South African's yard.

Cody Mo secured a win courtesy of the hugely progressive Emblazon (Zoustar). The Hong Kong Derby-nominated son of Zoustar (Northern Meteor) made it three wins in a row and four for the season – all under two pound-

claiming Jerry Chau – when he took out the Class 3 Yan Tin Handicap (1400m).

Chau and trainer Lui completed doubles when Galactic Voyage (Impending) prevailed in the Class 3 Tai Hing Handicap (1200m). The win improved Lui's tally for the season to 25 wins. Chau moved on to 21.

Manfred Man and Dylan Browne McMonagle combined as Aurora Patch (Showtime) won the Class 3 Wu King Handicap (1200m, dirt), the five-year-old's third win of the season. Ricky Yiu's The Concentration (Hellbent) claimed a fourth win from 31 starts, with Maxime Guyon registering his 14th winner of the season in the Class 5 Fu Tai Handicap (1400m), and David Hayes kept up the pressure on Newnham at the top of the trainers' standings with his 34th win of the season, when Harry Bentley guided All Round
