'That was breathtaking' – star filly Sheza Alibi dismantles Doncaster field

Peter Moody was left pinching himself after Sheza Alibi (Saxon Warrior) confirmed herself as the latest superstar filly in his care with an unforgettable victory in Saturday's Doncaster Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) at Randwick.

Sheza Alibi, the \$10,000 weanling purchase for her sole owner, central Queensland grazier Fred Noffke, pushed her earnings to \$3.7 million with her seventh victory in ten starts, her fifth win in a row and her second Group 1 in succession.

And she did it in emphatic, effortless style,

making a field of quality older milers look second-rate on a Soft 7 track.

Jumping from gate 13 of 16 for Jamie Melham under her featherweight 49 kilograms, Sheza Alibi settled second-last as a solid pace was set up front. She came as the widest runner around the home turn, but in just a few strides after the 350 metres, the filly flew past her rivals to turn the event into a procession, streaking home to score by 4.3 lengths as \$1.90 favourite.

In doing so, she put herself in rarified company, becoming the first three-year-old filly to take Australia's greatest mile race since the mighty Sunline (Desert Sun) won the first of her two Doncasters in 1999. **Continued on page 2**

Campione D'Italia cements stud future with Sires' Produce success

Newgate-China Horse Club colt Campione D'Italia (Snitzel) might not yet have the champion status hinted by his name, but proved himself a special colt in the making with a commanding victory in Saturday's ATC Sires' Produce Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Randwick.

After a poor tenth on debut was followed by a barnstorming win in the Skyline Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m), Campione D'Italia was one of the unlucky runners of the Golden Slipper (Gr 1, 1200m), drifting back to last by the home turn but making up many lengths to finish a 2.1-length fourth behind Guest House (Home Affairs). **Continued on page 3**

Continued from page 1 And with the ease of her victories – including a 3.2-length romp in the Randwick Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) at her previous start – Sheza Alibi has quickly earned mention among some extremely illustrious names.

She'll not finish unbeaten, thanks to three minor placings in her formative first five starts, but Moody was still left pondering how lucky he is to have the rising star, having also trained the 25-from-25 phenomenon Black Caviar (Bel Esprit).

"I've been blessed to train one of the greatest we'll ever see, but this filly is just amazing," Moody said. "I'm not saying she's Black Caviar, but that was just – how good?"

"It's emotional. She's a special, special horse. Where's the ceiling? You don't know."

Moody, who now trains in partnership with Katherine Coleman, was led to invoke the name of another special female – who is unbeaten so far – in the 11-from-11 Autumn Glow (The Autumn Sun), who's been outstanding over the mile and is also set to grace the Randwick carnival in next Saturday's Queen Elizabeth Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m).

"It's special. I'm happy Autumn Glow wasn't here, I can tell you that. She's a superstar," he said.

"The day will probably come – let's hope it does for Australian racing – where they meet. I'm happy to stay away from her for as long as we possibly can, but I don't think we're going to hide from too many, when you see a performance like that. She's just a very special horse."

In the other race within this one, that for second place, Autumn Boy (The Autumn Sun) took the honours, as he did behind the same filly in the Randwick Guineas, as a \$10 second elect. His Chris Waller-trained stablemate Militarize (Dundeel) was third at \$41.

The fact Sheza Alibi started odds-on in a Doncaster, and was the only horse in single figures in the market of a 16-horse edition of the history-steeped race, speaks volumes for her rare and exciting quality.

"That was breathtaking," Moody said. "The second colt is a super colt and what she does is just amazing. Quite phenomenal, and she's so nondescript. She doesn't stand out at home in training, she's just a tradesman. She's got a great hip, a big deep girth and a hell of a lot of ability."

"I thought she had the perfect prep. She won the Guineas, got the ballot exemption [for the Doncaster], we missed the penalty and it just set up beautifully."

"The only thing was the soft ground. Good horses like to be close to on top of the ground, any good horse does. Nothing goes faster with cut in the ground."

"[But] crikey -- hard to go much faster than her, her last couple."

Melham was equally enraptured after

riding Sheza Alibi for the first time, with regular partner Luke Nolen unable to make the weight.

"What a horse," said Melham, who made a special effort to make the 49 kilos given the horse involved.

"I trialled her the other day and she gave me a nice feel, but with blinkers on today, Jesus Christ, I've never sat on a horse that has given me goosebumps like that before."

"I got pushed a bit wide and got back a bit too far, but we got there in about a few strides and she just sailed away from them."

"They have a very, very special horse on their hands. I've sat on some very special horses before, but I don't think any come close to the feel she just gave me then."

"I'm very happy to be hungry to be riding a horse like this."

Moody, celebrating his 63rd Group 1 and his sixth with Coleman, was delighted to sit his first Doncaster trophy alongside those of Australia's other main shorter-distance handicaps.

"It's very special. This is one of Australia's great races. I've won a Newmarket [with Black Caviar and Wanted], I've won a Stradbroke Handicap [with Mid Summer Music]. Now to win the Doncaster – that's the big three handicaps in Australian racing" he said, perhaps forgetting in the excitement the Melbourne and Caulfield Cups, the latter of which he won with Incentivise (Shamus Award) in 2021.

And Moody was also thrilled to take the Doncaster on the same day that Brett Cavanaugh, his old childhood friend from Charleville, Queensland, won the \$1 million Country Championships Final (1400m), with Chidiac (Better Than Ready). **Continued on page 3**

Continued from page 2 It was a teenaged Cavanaugh who convinced a 16-year-old Moody to join him strapping at Randwick for the great TJ Smith in the mid-80s.

"I'll tell you what is very special to me, my great mate Brett Cavanaugh won the Country Championships earlier in the day," Moody said.

"We are two boys from Charleville, a small town of 2000 people in Western Queensland and we've just won two feature races at Randwick on Doncaster Day."

Bred by Queensland hobby breeders Fred and Desley Monsour, Sheza Alibi was bought by Noffke for that bargain \$10,000 on Inglis Digital.

She is the sole winner from four to race out of Sheza Gypsy (Shaft), a half-sister to a Hong Kong Listed winner who was covered by Saxon Warrior (Deep Impact) during his third of four seasons at Coolmore Australia in 2021 at a fee of \$13,750 (inc GST).

However, Sheza Alibi's younger half-brother Nomadic (King's Legacy) was stakes-placed in his third start at Randwick last weekend, running third in the Baillieu Handicap (Gr 3, 1400m) for two-year-olds.

The sole Australian stakes winner for Saxon Warrior, Sheza Alibi is one of two Group 1 victors worldwide for the son of Deep Impact (Sunday Silence), after his first-crop son Victoria Road won the Breeders Cup Juvenile Turf (Gr 1, 8f) in 2022.

Saxon Warrior hasn't shuttled to Australia since his fourth stint in 2022 and is currently standing in Ireland for €10,000 (approx. AU\$16,524).

Sheza Gypsy wasn't served in 2023 or 2024, but was covered by Newgate's Ozzmosis (Zoustar) last spring.

Campione D'Italia cements stud future with Sires' Produce success

Newgate-China Horse Club colt Campione D'Italia (Snitzel) might not yet have the champion status hinted by his name, but proved himself a special colt in the making with a commanding victory in Saturday's ATC Sires' Produce Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Randwick.

After a poor tenth on debut was followed by a barnstorming win in the Skyline Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m), Campione D'Italia was one of the unlucky runners of the Golden Slipper (Gr 1, 1200m), drifting back to last by the home turn but making up many lengths to finish a 2.1-length fourth behind Guest House (Home Affairs).

The run indicated the extra 200 metres of the

Sires' would be ideal, and that's how it panned out for the Chris Waller-trained juvenile.

Drifting late to lose favouritism and jump as a \$4.20 second elect, the half-million dollar yearling was taken back again from barrier three by James McDonald, settling eighth of the 13.

With only a moderate tempo set, McDonald improved a few places on the fence by the home turn, and eased into the clear at the 350 metres. At that point he still had five lengths to make up as leader Rachini (Zoustar) found the kick expected after an easy time in front.

But Campione D'Italia settled in for the fight and hauled in Rachini at the 150, and had enough in reserve at the end to win by 0.8 lengths from Gai Waterhouse and Adrain Bott's fast-finishing \$15 shot Miss Chanel (Tagaloa).

Continued from page 3 Another Waller-trained colt by Snitzel (Redoute's Choice) – Fireball – was the same margin further back in third, 3.1 lengths ahead of fellow \$18 chance Rachini.

Streisand (Magnus) – the Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner and Golden Slipper runner-up who was bought during the week by Yulong in a \$5.5 million deal – appeared to disappoint running seventh as a \$3.30 favourite, one place behind another recent Yulong acquisition in Paradoxium (Extreme Choice), at \$8.

The victory of Campione D'Italia in the Inglis-sponsored Sires' Produce brought together Australia's two major auction houses.

Magic Millions boss Gerry Harvey bred the colt and sold him via his Baramul Stud draft at the Gold Coast last January to the China Horse Club, Newgate and partners for \$500,000, but stayed in for 20 per cent.

Harvey was thus delighted to receive the winners' trophy from Inglis Bloodstock CEO Sebastian Hutch, not missing the opportunity for a few cheeky digs at his rival auction boss.

Harvey told reporters: "The colt got passed in in the ring and I told [Newgate managing director] Henry Field, 'I want \$600,000', and he said, 'I'll give you \$500,000', and I said, 'Get lost'.

"In the end I took it and luckily I kept 20 per cent for myself."

Waller was full of praise for Campione D'Italia, who cemented his stud future at Newgate with his maiden Group 1 success.

"He's a young horse. Today was his fourth career start and each run has got a little bit better," Waller said after his 194th Group 1 victory.

"His run in the Golden Slipper was amazing. He just got too far back. It was no-one's fault, and the horse is learning all the time.

"He got a lovely draw today, and that was the difference between having him in the firing line or going back like he was last start. It was good to see him knuckle down and get the job done.

"He's got raw talent. His first start he did everything wrong, just because he thought, 'Right, let's get the race over and done with.' We had to harness that a little bit and bring him back. He's a lovely colt."

While the style of his win suggested Campione D'Italia would be suited by the extra distance of the Champagne Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) in two weeks, Waller was non-committal on a start. He said the colt would thrive at the distance in a Guineas race as a three-year-old, but is unsure about tackling the Champagne at this stage of his development.

"We'll see how he comes through it," Waller said. "Obviously it's a big deal to win for a colt, but there's so much to come for him. That'll be

the only thing swaying us. He'll get a Guineas trip, it's just a matter of whether he's ready for it now."

McDonald agreed the future looked especially bright for Campione D'Italia.

"He's a sensational horse. He's been a work in progress and Mr Harvey told me, 'Make sure I keep my hands down. I don't want that horse throwing his head,'" McDonald said.

"He's beautifully bred and is a horse with a real future, I'm sure he'll run the 1600 metres right out.

"It was great to see him put it together today. We've always had a big opinion of him. Chris and the team have done such a good job to keep him improving with each start."

Campione D'Italia comes from a well-performed family. He's the fifth foal of 1200-metre winner Medaglia Valore (Medaglia D'Oro), who's had four winners from five runners and has also thrown the Group 2-placed Snitzel Miss (Snitzel) and the Group 3-placed Flashing Steel (Not A Single Doubt).

Second dam Military Rose (General Nediym) won five stakes races including the STC Reisling Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) which helped her become second top filly on the 2009-10 Australasian 2YO Classification. She's also the second dam of dual Group 3-winning two-year-old Espionage (Zoustar).

Medaglia Valore's colt by Zoustar (Northern Meteor) sold for \$750,000 to trainer Mick Price at Magic Millions Gold Coast in January. She missed to the late Wootton Bassett (Ifraaj) in 2024 but was covered by Zoustar again last November.

Continued from page 4 becomes the 27th individual Group 1 winner for Snitzel (Redoute's Choice) and is one 170 stakes winners worldwide from 1,717 runners for the stallion – a stakes winner strike-rate of 9.9 per cent. The Arrowfield titan died last June but is still a runaway leader on the Australian general sires' table, seeking his fifth champion's title.

Joliestar all set for Royal Ascot raid after fifth Group 1 success

The TJ Smith Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) was the next on the card and Chris Waller's Joliestar (Zoustar) delivered the champion trainer his second Group 1 of the day and her fifth overall, before a Royal Ascot mission was confirmed for the flying five-year-old.

Randwick's weight-for-age autumn sprint highlight was an intriguing betting race, with both Joliestar and Giga Kick (Scissor Kick) attracting late support, the mare starting a \$3.90 favourite and the gelding a \$4.60 equal second elect.

And that assessment proved accurate as Joliestar lived up to the punters' support, outsprinting Giga Kick at the finish to score by 0.6 lengths.

Settling midfield of the nine on the inside for James McDonald, Joliestar assumed the lead from Overpass (Vancouver) at the 250 metres while Giga Kick was winding up after travelling deeper in the field.

Despite racing on the inferior section of the track, Joliestar took a one-length lead by the 150 metres and was able to comfortably withstand Giga Kick's finish, in a win which took her earnings past \$9 million.

Skybird (Exosphere) finished another 0.4 lengths back in third in spite of the \$41 hope's barrier antics pre-race.

Meanwhile, the boom lowered further on Godolphin colt Tentyris (Street Boss). Another who was backed in, from \$5 to start \$4.60, the Anthony and Sam Freedman-trained sprinter didn't look at home in his first attempt on wet ground, travelling last and finishing last.

At the other end it was all almost routine for Joliestar, who was scoring a third straight success and back-to-back top tier wins after taking Randwick's Canterbury Stakes (Gr 1, 1300m) the start previous.

She may have to battle for air time alongside two contemporary females Autumn Glow (The Autumn Sun) and Sheza Alibi (Saxon Warrior), but such is Joliestar's ability – and maturity after 21 starts – that Waller had no hesitation

in confirming a Royal Ascot mission post-race, targeting the Queen Elizabeth II Jubilee Stakes (Gr 1, 6f) in June.

"I would go to Royal Ascot and bring her back for The Everest – she has just started to mature as a racehorse," Waller said.

"I think we will probably go for the Jubilee at Royal Ascot. We had the trip planned well before today but we wanted to see her run well in the TJ to cement her place for England.

"She'll have a little bit of down time now and then we'll work our way back from Royal Ascot. We'll do our usual jump-outs and trials and get her on the plane.

"She goes so well fresh and no doubt will represent Australasia very well on the grand stage," the expat Kiwi said of the Cambridge Stud-owned mare. **Continued on page 6**

Continued from page 5 Waller said Saturday's victory highlighted the development of Joliestar over the past year.

She was good enough to win Flemington's Newmarket Handicap (Gr 1, 1200m) in March last year, but then disappointed in the T J Smith when ninth as a \$3.30 favourite.

"That is the difference between her this year compared to last year," Waller said.

"Last year, she could pull out a belter but wide draws and luck in running could get her beaten. But she is a more complete racehorse now."

McDonald, after taking his Australian Group 1 record to 134, said any doubts from earlier in her career had been erased by Joliestar now.

"She has had her doubters before, but they have no leg to stand on now. She is a grand final winner," he said.

"I just let her gallop [today]. I learnt not to organise her too much. Even though I would have preferred to be on the outside, I wasn't too deterred by the inside because I had room, she was organised and as it happens so often, us jockeys overplay the bias a little bit.

"When I walked the track I didn't think it was that bad, where I was."

Asked about Royal Ascot, McDonald said: "It's very exciting and no doubt she'll be a force to be reckoned with."

A \$950,000 Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale purchase for Cambridge Stud's Brendan and Jo Lindsay, Joliestar now has ten wins and seven placings from 21 starts.

With prize money of \$9.03 million, she

is the highest earner for reigning champion sire Zoustar, and one of the Widden Stud flagbearer's 79 stakes winners from 1,187 runners, at 6.7 per cent.

It was a red-letter day for the son of Northern Meteor (Encosta De Lago), having also sired two new stakes winners across the country in Plaintiff and Zoupurring, who scored in the PJ Bell Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) at Randwick and the Railway Stakes (Listed, 1100m) at Oakbank respectively.

Bred by Chris and Jane Barham, she is the best of six winners from six to race out of the Group 1-placed and Group 2-winning Fastnet Rock (Danehill) mare Jolie Bay, herself a sister to both Queen Elizabeth II Jubilee Stakes winner Merchant Navy and Listed winner Setanta.

Cambridge also bought Jolie Bay's filly by Anamoe (Street Boss) at this year's Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale, for \$470,000.

The mare now has a Joliestar's weanling brother at foot, and was covered by Darley's Too Darn Hot (Dubawi) last spring. **Cont. on page 7**

Baker's Green Spaces a cut above in Australian Derby

Trainer Bjorn Baker was thrilled to emulate his father Murray in winning the Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) at Randwick on Saturday as Godolphin colt Green Spaces (Street Boss) continued his sire's hot run of success with a dominant victory.

Well supported at \$4.40 and ridden superbly by Rachel King, Green Spaces settled midfield while a moderate pace was set by Godolphin's more fancied runner Observer (Ghaiyyath), the \$3 favourite.

So dominant in winning the VRC Derby (Gr 1, 2500m) last spring and the Australian Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) earlier this preparation, Observer was a beaten force by the 300 metres as another son of Ghaiyyath (Dubawi) Storm Leopard (\$4.60) - took the lead soon after straightening.

But while that \$4.60 chance gave his backers hope early in the straight, Green Spaces was unwinding with an irresistible run down the centre of the track, and he came away to win by 3.2 lengths.

Dezignation (So You Think) - the rank outside of the field at \$151 - again showed trainer Matt Smith's knack with longshots in major races, finishing stoutly to be the best of the rest in second place, while Storm Leopard held on for third and Observer managed fifth.

Green Spaces follows his three-quarter brother Trekking (Street Cry) in becoming the second Group 1 victor from six runners for their dam Outdoor (Redoute's Choice).

Baker, the Warwick Farm-based expat Kiwi, is renowned for never letting slip the chance to celebrate, but this win meant more than most.

New Zealand-based Murray Baker has a powerful reputation as a trainer of young stayers, and has won the Australian Derby five times, as well as - by Bjorn's recollection - the VRC Derby, two New Zealand Derbies (Gr 1, 2400m) and a Wellington Derby (Gr 2, 2400m).

And thus a breakthrough Derby victory had Bjorn high on emotion at Randwick, saying he'd spoken to his father about the race several times in the past week.

"He said, 'Don't leave him short son, don't leave him short,'" said the younger Baker, who'd assured his father he hadn't. "I said,

'Murray, we're not training for jumps!' It's not Warnambool.

"But you know what - fitness always wins.

"It's so special. We're very proud."

Baker, who also saddled Blue Door (Stay Inside) for a tough debut success in the Kindergarten Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) in the opening race on Saturday's card, was high on confidence about Green Spaces following his fast-finishing second in the Rosehill Guineas (Gr 1, 2000m) but also based on his trackwork during the week.

"I was very confident he would win and I thought he might put a space on them, and he did," Baker said.

"When they are in the zone like that - his trackwork has been in the zone - I was very confident. I couldn't have had him any better going into today.

"Every time I looked at him in the box, his coat was great. He's in the zone and his work on Tuesday was great.

"The rain came this morning and I was very confident he was fit enough."

Celebrating his 12th Group 1, Baker was also delighted for his jockey and friend King, who scored her eighth.

He forecast the pair might aim to bring up another one with Green Spaces at Flemington in November.

"She's done so much work for our stable and she delivers, she delivers on the big stage. She rode him perfectly today, it was an exceptional ride," he said.

"And I love taking Victoria's money, so Melbourne Cup - bring it on!"

King was in turn full of praise for Green Spaces, and his trainer.

"It's just satisfying," the winning rider said. "I've had so much belief in this horse, the whole team has. They've done an amazing job and Bjorn has just timed it to perfection.

"He's a beautiful horse and it set up perfectly for him today. I was very confident it would. He just relaxed so well, did everything I asked - a very satisfying win."

Bred by Darley, Green Spaces is one of three stakes winners for Outdoor, with dual Group 1-winning sprinter Trekking also joined on that list by Winnie Star, a Listed victor in Macau. Outdoor has also thrown the stakes-placed Plymstock (Ribchester).

A three-time winner for Anthony Freedman, Outdoor now has a yearling colt by Pinatubo (Shamardal) and a weanling colt by Harry Angel (Dark Angel), and was covered by new Darley sire Traffic Warden (Street Boss) last December.

The 21-year-old Street Boss, who stood at Darley's Northwood Park last spring for \$66,000 (inc GST), is enjoying an exceptional run of form.

With elite winners this year in Tentyris, Tempted and Pericles, he headed into Saturday ranked seventh on the Australian general sires' table and emerged one place better, after a previous best finish of tenth in 2023.

Green Spaces becomes Street Boss's 14th Group 1 victor, among 88 stakes winners from 1,517 runners at 5.8 per cent.

Arrowfield's late stalwart Snitzel (Redoute's Choice) sired his 27th individual Group 1 winner when Campione D'Italia (2 c ex Medaglia Valore, by Medaglia D'Oro) landed Saturday's ATC Sires' Produce Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Randwick. Bred by Magic Millions boss Gerry Harvey and sold via his Baramul Stud draft at the Gold Coast last January, going for \$500,000 to the China Horse Club, Newgate and partners, Campione D'Italia is one of four winners from five runners Medaglia Valore (Medaglia D'Oro). The mare has also thrown the Group 2-placed Snitzel Miss (Snitzel) and the Group 3-placed Flashing Steel (Not A Single Doubt). Medaglia Valore is a daughter of Military Rose (General Nediym), the winner of five stakes races including the STC

Reisling Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) - which helped her become second top filly on the 2009-10 Australasian 2YO Classification. Military Rose is also the second dam of dual Group 3-winning two-year-old Espionage (Zoustar). Medaglia Valore's colt by Zoustar (Northern Meteor) sold for \$750,000 to trainer Mick Price at Magic Millions Gold Coast in January. She missed to the late Wootton Bassett (Iffraaj) in 2024 but was covered by Zoustar again last November. Campione D'Italia is one of 170 stakes winners for Snitzel, who died last June but is a runaway leader on the Australian general sires' table, seeking his fifth champion's title.

14 for Street Boss

Darley's flying sire Street Boss (Street Cry) notched up his 14th individual Group 1 winner when Green Spaces (3 c ex Outdoor, by Redoute's Choice) posted a dominant victory in Saturday's Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) at Randwick. A homebred for Godolphin, Green Spaces is one of three stakes winners out of Outdoor (Redoute's Choice), following the feats of dual Group 1-winning sprinter Trekking (Street Cry) and Winnie Star (Medaglia D'Oro), a Listed victor in Macau. Outdoor, who has also thrown the stakes-placed Plymstock (Ribchester), has a yearling colt by Pinatubo (Shamardal) and a weanling colt by Harry Angel (Dark Angel), and was covered by Darley's

Traffic Warden (Street Boss) last December. Street Boss stood at Darley's Northwood Park last spring for \$66,000 (inc GST). Green Spaces is among 88 stakes winners for the stallion, who has also had elite-level wins this term with Tentyris, Tempted and Pericles.

Third for Stay Inside

Newgate Farm's first-season sire Stay Inside (Extreme Choice) continued his strong start at stud when Blue Door (2 f ex Notting Hill by Piero) landed Saturday's Kindergarten Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) on debut at Randwick. Trained by Bjorn Baker and ridden by Rachel King, the filly was sent out at \$4.40 and settled in just behind and outside the leader, and hit the front with ease at the 300-metre mark to defeat The Next Episode (Snitzel) by 0.3 lengths, with Under Focus (Too Darn Hot) just 0.9 lengths away in third. Bred by Yarraman Park, Blue Door was purchased by Gai Waterhouse, Adrian Bott and Kestrel Thoroughbreds at the 2025 Inglis Australian Easter Sale. She hails from a strong Australian family, being out of Notting Hill (Piero) - a daughter of Monsoon Wedding (Danehill), herself a sister to the late champion sire Redoute's Choice. The victory provided Stay Inside with his third stakes winner, joining Incognito and Lassified. The son of Extreme Choice (Not A Single Doubt) stood for a fee of \$66,000 (inc GST) in 2025.

Baker's bold call pays off with Blue Door

A bold call by trainer Bjorn Baker to start off Stay Inside filly Blue Door in stakes company paid off when the filly proved herself professional beyond her experience in Saturday's Kindergarten Stakes at Randwick. Baker admitted it was an unconventional path to stakes success, given the filly, raced by John Singleton and his daughter Jess, had just one trial before debuting at Group level. "We don't often ask a two-year-old to go straight into a stakes race on debut but she's very good," he said. "She's shown exceptional ability since we've had her. She was a great trial winner and it's great to win for Singo and the team." Winning rider Rachel King echoed the trainer's sentiments, noting the filly's attitude was key. "I was a little wary off only one trial, but her gallop on Tuesday was super," she said. "She's a real racehorse, she wants to win. She's very professional and has a great will to find the line." Being out of Notting Hill, Singleton revealed the inspiration for the filly's name stemmed from a visit to his daughter in London. "Jess was living in Notting Hill and I went to visit her," he said. "I noticed all the doors in her street were painted blue and when she went out, I thought why not paint her door red. But when she came home, she wasn't happy and suspected it was me, so I had to have the door painted blue again." Blue Door opened a brilliant afternoon for Baker and King, the pair combining for a dominant Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) later on with Green Spaces (Street Boss).

Five for Farnan

Kia Ora Stud's Farnan (Not A Single Doubt) provided a timely result on Day 1 of The Championships at Randwick when Profoundly (3 f ex Profound Wisdom by Al Samer) became his fifth stakes winner. The half-sister to sharp two-year-old Sebonack (Capitalist) powered clear in the final stages under Tommy Berry to land Saturday's Adrian Knox Stakes (Gr 3, 2000m) for trainer Michael Freedman. The filly defeated Soverato (Vadamos) by over two lengths, with Satono Invader (Satono Aladdin) further back in third. Profoundly was purchased for \$65,000 at the 2024 Inglis Classic Yearling Sale and has now recorded three wins from ten starts. She is out of the Al Samer (Redoute's Choice) mare Profound Wisdom, a half-sister to Group 1-producing sire Santos (I Am Invincible), and hails from the family of Group 1 winner Fat Al (Al Maher). The victory provides another black-type success for Farnan, who continues to build a solid record at stud. The son of Not A Single Doubt (Redoute's Choice) stood for \$77,000 (inc GST) in 2025.

Freedman filly firms Oaks claims

The Freedman family colours were back in the spotlight at Randwick when Profoundly strengthened her Australian Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) claims with a victory in the Adrian Knox Stakes. Prepared by Michael Freedman and part-owned by brother Lee, the filly continued her upward trajectory following a last-start placing in the Kembla Grange Classic (Gr 3, 1600m). Lee Freedman, who purchased the filly for \$65,000 and oversaw her early education, was confident improvement was to come stepping up in trip. "I bought her when I was training for \$65,000," he said. "Then when I turned it up, I was looking for a good trainer, and my brother rang me. I was really happy that the form from Kembla worked out, because a lot of people were saying it [Kembla Grange Classic] was slowly run and it wouldn't be good form. But

I just knew that this filly had improvement to come, and we'd never run her over a mile-and-a-quarter. All she wanted to do was stay." Michael Freedman indicated the filly is likely to back up in the Australian Oaks at Randwick next week if she pulls up well. "Why not? I think we'll be here next week," he said. Berry was confident the filly could handle the quick turnaround. "She is a very clean-winded filly. She pulled up lovely then," the winning rider said. "She spends no petrol in the run, and she does it without any effort."

11 for The Autumn Sun

Four-time winner Autumn Break (3 g ex Isdaal by Dubawi) provided Albury trainer Kym Davison with his first metropolitan success when landing Saturday's Carbine Club Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m) at Randwick. The three-year-old, who had been an emergency for the \$1 million Country Championships Final (1400m), instead lined up in the Group 3 and delivered in style, producing a well-timed finish to defeat a field of progressive three-year-olds. Bred by Arrowfield Stud, the gelding was purchased by his trainer for just \$40,000 at the 2024 Inglis Classic Sale and has now won four of his seven starts for his stable. The Autumn Sun (Redoute's Choice) can seemingly do no wrong, with Autumn Break giving the Arrowfield sire his 11th individual stakes winner. He stood for a fee of \$66,000 (inc GST) in 2025.

Autumn Break delivers Davison breakthrough win

When failing to gain a start in the \$1 million Country Championships Final at Randwick, trainer Kym Davison pivoted with Autumn Break and it proved a winning move. Having initially set the three-year-old for the rich feature, he ended up celebrating a breakthrough metro success courtesy of the gelding's Carbine Club Stakes win. "First city winner, so not a bad one to crack the ice with," Davison said. "I was hoping to be in the next race, but a great consolation.

I saw this race and said, 'well, we're going up there anyway, so we'll have a throw at the stumps.' Sent out at \$8 under Sam Clipperton, Autumn Break denied the Chris Waller-trained Kilman (Super Seth) by a narrow margin, with Matias (Snitzel) a short head away in third. The victory carried added significance for Davison, who revealed the stable has endured a difficult week following the passing of his brother. "It's been a hard week. We lost my brother a week ago," he said. "He had been unwell for a while, but you've got to pick yourself up." Davison indicated the gelding would now head for a spell with a view to targeting races later in the year. "The Kosciuszko [1200m], he'd go alright in that," he said. "His first start was over 1200 metres and he should have won that Highway here first-up, so we'll try to push onto that if we can."

Chidiac romps away with Country Championships Final

Chidiac (Better Than Ready) delivered a career-defining performance when capturing the Country Championships Final (1400m) at Randwick, providing Brett and Georgie Cavanough with their biggest success in partnership. Ridden by Zac Purton, the progressive mare travelled strongly throughout before asserting her superiority in the finish to

score by a length from Graceful Ellen (Spieth), with Micro Mikki (Mikki Isle) a further 1.5 lengths away in third. "I've got to try and hold it together a bit, very special today to do it with Georgie," Brett Cavanough said. "She tipped Chidiac all week, she had faith in her." Georgie added: "She's been my pick all along, she didn't let us down, she's a very classy mare." Purton, who grew up in country New South Wales, was delighted to land the feature. "I was a country boy my whole childhood, so it's great to team up with someone from there and win a race as important as this," he said. "She travelled really well, at no stage did she give me any concerns... she was comfortable where she was and when I asked her to go, she kept going all the way." A \$24,000 Magic Millions Gold Coast Book 2 purchase, Chidiac has now won six of her 11 starts and over \$1 million in prize money for owner Gerry Harvey, with Cavanough suggesting bigger targets such as the Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1400m) could now be on the agenda.

Newlook moves into Sydney Cup contention after first Group win

French import Newlook (New Bay) thrust himself into Sydney Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) contention following his win in Saturday's Chairman's Quality (Gr 2, 2600m) at Randwick.

The Trent Busuttin and Natalie Young-trained stayer relished the softer conditions to produce a sustained finishing effort, improving sharply on his previous Australian runs. Ridden by Rachel King, Newlook (\$8.50) charged down the centre of the track to defeat Campaldino (Ghibellines) by 1.2 lengths, with Juja Kibo (Belardo) the same margin further away in third and Travolta (Lope De Vega) close up in fourth. The victory provides Newlook with ballot exemption and a penalty-free entry into next Saturday's Sydney Cup, where he is set to carry just 50 kilos. King was confident the gelding would take improvement from his previous fifth in the Manion Cup (Gr 3, 2400m) last month. "I was confident he would take good improvement from his last start, he was only second up there," she said. "He still probably blew out at the 50 metres, I thought I was going to win easy at the furlong but he just got a bit tired. But he'll take good improvement again. I galloped him during the week and was confident he would run well over this distance." A Listed winner in France prior to import, Newlook now shapes as a genuine contender to complete the Chairman's Quality-Sydney Cup double, while runner-up Campaldino also enhanced his claims, with Tim Clark noting: "He bounced back to form today, then next Saturday with a few kilos less he is going to be hard to beat."

Zoustar lands stakes treble across standout Saturday

On an afternoon headlined by his T J Smith Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) heroine Joliestar, Widden Stud's reigning Champion Sire Zoustar (Northern Meteor) landed a remarkable interstate stakes treble on Saturday.

Two of those were new stakes winners for the son of Northern Meteor (Encosta De Lago), the first being unbeaten filly Plaintiff (3 f ex Prompt Response, by Beneteau) who took out the P J Bell Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) at Randwick.

Trained by Peter Snowden and ridden by Jordan Childs, the filly made it four wins from four starts when she stormed home on the outside to defeat Nepo Baby (Lucky Vega) by a half-length, with Tomato Toastie (Too Darn Hot) a further half length away in third.

Bred by Widden Stud and partners, Plaintiff was purchased for \$2.2 million by James Harron Bloodstock at Inglis Easter in 2024 and is the best of three winners from three foals to race out of Tatts Tiara

(Gr 1, 1400m) winner Prompt Response (Beneteau).

Prompt Response sadly died last year, adding further significance to the win today, with Plaintiff being her final foal. Still lightly raced, she has shown a sharp turn of foot in each of her victories and shapes as a filly with considerable upside.

The treble was completed by Railway Stakes (Listed, 1100m) winner Zoupurring (6 g ex Tara's Spur, by Flying Spur), who swiftly brought his sire's worldwide tally to 79 stakes winners with a maiden black type victory at Oakbank.

Trained by Michael Hickmott and ridden by Teodore Nugent, the ultra-honest gelding held off Great Maximus (Magnus) by a half-length to record the biggest win of his career. Winning Revolution (Winning Rupert) finished another 0.6 lengths back in third.

A \$100,000 Inglis Melbourne Premier Yearling Sale purchase, Zoupurring has now won eight races and over \$350,000 in prize money. He is one of six winners from eight foals to race out of the Flying Spur (Danehill) mare Tara's Spur.

15 for Russian Revolution

Nine-time winner Hughes (6 g ex No More Tears, by Darci Brahma) continued his rise through the grades when landing Saturday's Victoria Handicap (Gr 3, 1400m) at Caulfield, becoming a stakes-winning half-brother to Group 1 winner turned Newgate Farm sire Ozzmosis (Zoustar). Trained by Gavin Bedggood and ridden by Jett Stanley, the gelding enjoyed a soft run before producing a sharp turn of foot to defeat Athantos (I Am Immortal) by 1.5 lengths, shaving 0.13 seconds off Exceed And Excel's (Danehill) 2003 course record of 1:21:20 for 1400 metres. Purchased for \$140,000 at the Inglis Premier Yearling Sale from the Sledmere Stud draft, Hughes has now recorded nice wins from 25 starts with earning in excess of \$580,000. The victory provided Russian Revolution (Snitzel) with his 15th individual stakes winner. The son of Snitzel stood for a fee of \$33,000 (inc GST) in 2025.

13 for Fiorente

Late Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m)-winning sire Fiorente (Monsun) recorded his 13th individual stakes winner when Ambassadorial (5 g ex Showcase, by Big Brown) won Saturday's Easter Cup (Gr 3, 2000m) at Caulfield. The Tony and Calvin-trained gelding made it three wins in a row, stalking the speed and proving too sharp in the straight. Bred by Sun Bloodstock, Ambassadorial was purchased for \$22,500 at the 2022 Inglis Premier Yearling Sale by Jane Chapple-Hyam and is raced in partnership with Ms A E Peacock. He has amassed over \$500,000 in prize money for his owners.

Flying Ambassadorial set to press on to Mornington Cup

In-form gelding Ambassadorial extended his winning sequence to three with a dominant performance in the Easter Cup at Caulfield on Saturday, continuing his sharp rise since joining the Tony and Calvin McEvoy stable. The five-year-old has thrived under his new

training arrangement, producing another polished display as the \$4 favourite under Logan Bates, defeating Sea What I Sea (Sea The Stars) by 1.5 lengths, with Immediacy (Tarzino) 0.1 lengths away in third. Tony McEvoy credited the turnaround in form to keeping the gelding fresh. "We've decided not to train him," McEvoy senior said. "We're still charging training fees - I hope Jane didn't hear that, but we're keeping him really fresh. He's a very light-fleshed, athletic horse and doesn't require a lot and if you look at his CV, he's been with trainers that do train them, so we decided to make a change." Originally trained by Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott before a stint with Alex Rae, Ambassadorial has now won three of his five starts since joining the McEvoy team, representing outstanding value for connections. Looking ahead, the stable is considering stepping him up in distance, with the Mornington Cup (Listed, 2400m) on April 18 a likely target. "We need to find out if he runs a mile and a half," McEvoy said. "If he does, it opens up a whole new path for him."

Mukhtalif scores on Australian debut

Mukhtalif (Sea The Stars) made a winning start to his Australian career when taking out the Robert Taranto Handicap (1800m) at Caulfield on Saturday for the Ciaran Maher stable. The Irish-bred four-year-old, sent out the \$4.60 favourite under Ben Allen, settled on speed before asserting in the straight to score by two lengths from Figlio D'Argento (D'Argento), with Merchant Flyer (Merchant Navy) just a further 0.1 lengths away in third. A dual winner in the UK at Newmarket and York for William Haggas prior to his import, Mukhtalif is expected to be placed carefully as he progresses through the grades. Assistant trainer Jack Turnbull said the stable would look to make use of the gelding's rating before stepping him up. "Whilst he's fresh, I don't think we'll have to rush him up in trip," Turnbull said. "There's an 1800-metre race

at Flemington later this month... but we'll see how he is. He was well bought and hopefully he's our next progressive winter stayer." Mukhtalif was positive from a wide draw to sit outside the leader before taking control on straightening, impressing with his ability to relax and build through his gears. Allen noted the gelding's enthusiasm through the line. "When the others caught up over the line he wanted to go again and it took me a while to pull him up," he said.

Nine for Gingerbread Man

Beatty (2 c ex Femmette, by Murtajill) gave his sire Gingerbread Man (Shamardal) his ninth individual stakes winner when the sharp colt took on his rivals to win the Perth Stakes (Listed, 1100m) at Ascot. Trained by Sean and Jake Casey and ridden by Chris Parnham, the unbeaten two-year-old made it three wins from as many starts, continuing his faultless record for the preparation. Bred in Western Australia, Beatty is out of Femmette, a winning daughter of Murtajill (Rock Of Gibraltar), and from the family of Gimcrack Stakes (Listed, 1100m) winner Refemme, a proven juvenile source in the state. He becomes the latest stakes winner for his Yarradale Stud-based sire, whose progeny have shown strong affinity for sprint distances.

Unbeaten Snitzel filly delivers back-to-back stakes wins

Aurum Belle (2 f ex Dame Giselle, by I Am Invincible) provided the late Snitzel with another stakes victory on Saturday when taking out the Gimcrack Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) at Ascot. The Neville Parnham-trained filly was given a peach ride by Brad Parnham, maintaining the filly's perfect record with a third consecutive victory, having added the Supremacy Stakes (Listed, 1000m) at her previous start. A \$725,000 Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale purchase, Aurum Belle is the first foal out of Group 2-winning juvenile Dame Giselle (I Am Invincible). The progressive juvenile has shown

natural speed and professionalism in all three outings and shapes as a leading contender for the upcoming Karrakatta Plate (Gr 2, 1200m) on April 25 back at Ascot.

Quokka hope resumes with tough Roma Cup win

Five-year-old Rope Them In (Playing God) resumed in winning fashion when taking out Saturday's Roma Cup (Gr 3, 1100m) at Ascot. Trained by Steve Wolfe and ridden by Shaun McGruddy, the consistent gelding dug deep to edge out Smooth Chino (Maschino) by a narrow margin, returning to the winner's list at stakes level. A \$60,000 Magic Millions Perth Yearling Sale purchase, Rope Them In has now won ten races and over \$1.4 million in prize money, adding to previous black-type success in the 2024 Colonel Reeves Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) and in the R.S. Crawford Stakes (Listed, 1200m) last October. Bred in Western Australia, he is out of the Real Jester mare Lead Rope (Real Jester) and continues to underline his credentials as a leading local sprinting prospect heading toward The \$5 million Quokka (1200m).

New Zealand

Third for Overshare

In landing Saturday's Gore Guineas (Listed, 1200m) at Riverton, Better Shared (3 f ex Eagle's Reach, by More Than Ready) took her sire Overshare's (I Am Invincible) individual stakes win tally to three. Trained by Kelvin Tyler and ridden by Amber Riddell, the filly made it two wins from five starts, controlling the race from the front before holding off Queen Of Sheeba (Impending) by 0.1 lengths, with Miss Starlight (Sweynesse) third, another 0.6 lengths away. Bred by Little River Thoroughbreds, Better Shared is the first stakes winner out of More Than Ready (Southern Halo) mare Eagle's Reach, herself a half-sister to five winners. Overshare was sold last year and now stands at stud in Indonesia.

Smooth Operator lands Riverton Cup and lucrative bonus

Smooth Operator (Turn Me Loose) delivered a tough staying performance to claim Saturday's Riverton Cup (2147m), securing both the \$46,000 feature and the \$50,000 Southern Cups Bonus. Prepared by Stephanie Faulkner, the six-year-old entered the race third on the bonus leaderboard after his Invercargill Cup (2600m) success in February, but with double points on offer his victory proved decisive. Ridden by Tina Comignaghi, Smooth Operator had to dig deep to overhaul local runner Riviera Rebel (Pure Champion), who set the pace and was still travelling strongly at the 200 metres. The gelding responded under pressure to grab

his rival late, scoring by 0.8 lengths. Faulkner said the result was especially pleasing after the horse overcame a setback following his last-start fifth in the Dunedin Gold Cup (Listed, 2400m). "He was a bit off after the Dunedin... he had a respiratory tract infection and it took a long while to recover," she said. Comignaghi, registering her first win in the race, praised the gelding's determination. "He's just so brave... when I asked him in the straight he just kept giving," she said.

La Diem earns black-type shot with Ellerslie upset

Well-bred filly La Diem (Wootton Bassett) produced a career-best to land Saturday's MyRacehorse 1600 (1600m) at Ellerslie,

prompting trainer Stephen Marsh to consider a stakes tilt next start. The daughter of Wootton Bassett (Iffraaj) out of Group 1 winner La Bella Diosa (So You Think) drifted to \$20 in betting but belied those odds with a determined display under Joe Doyle. Pressed forward early from a wide draw, La Diem sat outside the pacemaker and maintained a strong gallop throughout. She was joined late by Navy Ensign (U S Navy Flag), but dug deep to prevail by 0.2 lengths, with Celtic Tycoon (Written Tycoon) 0.3 lengths away in third. "I thought she went super but things didn't quite go right," he said. "She is a very good filly and I think she will go right through the grades."

Bosson denies Oh in Ellerslie finish

Opie Bosson spoiled apprentice Hyeontaek Oh's bid for a breakthrough New Zealand win when guiding Cannon Hill (Ardrossan) to victory in Saturday's Al Basti Equiworld Dubai Handicap (1300m) at Ellerslie. Oh looked set to make a winning start aboard Master Fay (Deep Field) after taking control turning for home, but Bosson produced Cannon Hill with a late run out wide to nab him on the line by a head, with Yaldi (Ardrossan) a further 0.9 lengths away in third. Trained by Tony Pike, the gelding was stepping back in trip and appreciated a patient ride after settling towards the rear from a wide draw. "He has taken a long time to strengthen up and he has run some very good races with not a lot of luck," Pike said. "I didn't want to go five weeks into the Easter, this was dropping back in trip but it sets him up nicely." Pike confirmed Cannon Hill would return to

Ellerslie in a fortnight for the Easter Handicap (Gr 3, 1600m). Bosson said the gelding would be better suited stepping back up in distance. "He travelled beautifully... it took him a while to wind up, so he is looking for that mile," he said.

Second for Upstart

Percy's Bar (3 f ex Honestly Deb, by Super Saver) provided Airdrie Stud sire Upstart (Flatter) with his second individual top-flight winner when she claimed Friday's Ashland Stakes (Gr 1, 8.5f) at Keeneland. Trained by Ben Colebrook, the three-year-old surged through along the rail under Luan Machado to score by two and a quarter lengths in the \$750,000 contest. The Hat Creek Racing-owned filly has now won three times at Keeneland, having previously been first past the post in last year's Alcibiades

Stakes (Gr 1, 8.5f) before being relegated for interference. Bred by the late Brereton Jones, Percy's Bar is out of Honestly Deb (Super Saver) from the family that has already produced multiple Kentucky Oaks (Gr 1, 9f) winners for her breeder, further enhancing her residual value. She becomes the first Grade 1-winning filly for Upstart and his second overall, joining Zandon, who captured the Blue Grass Stakes (Gr 1, 9f) at Keeneland in 2022. Upstart is standing for US\$25,000 (approx. AU\$36,275).

121 for Kitten's Joy

Remember Mamba (3 c ex Gizmo, by Uncle Mo) showed signs of inexperience late but held off his rivals with his strong finish showing his turn of foot to become the 121st individual stakes winner for the late Kitten's Joy (El Prado) when landing Friday's Transylvania Stakes (Gr 3, 8.5f) Keeneland, keeping his perfect three-for-three record intact. The Cherie DeVaux-trained colt defeated Honey Dutch (Knicks Go) by a half-length, with another neck back to Vasy (Space Blues) in third. Bred by Burning Daylight Farms and November Hill, the colt was a US\$270,000 purchase for Mayberry Farm at the 2024 Keeneland September Yearling Sale and races in the colours of Lee and Susan Searing's C R K Stable. Kitten's Joy died in 2022.
