Kiwi superstar Ohope Wins adds her name to history books with famous Oaks success

Star New Zealander Ohope Wins (Ocean Park) joined a select band of fillies to win the major Oaks double on both sides of the Tasman in storming to victory in the Australian Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) at Randwick.

Having won the New Zealand Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) two starts earlier at Ellerslie before a transfer to Chris Waller, Ohope Wins followed her close-up fourth in the Vinery Stud Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) with a popular Randwick triumph as \$2.60 favourite on Saturday.

Ridden by James McDonald, she continued

the phenomenal run of success for Australian racing's "power couple" Waller and McDonald have combined to win at least one Group 1 on a record of seven successive Saturdays, starting with Autumn Glow's (The Autumn Sun) success in the Verry Ellelegant Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) on February 28.

And Ohope Wins, recently declared New Zealand Bloodstock's Filly of the Year for the current season, became just the fourth filly to take out the New Zealand-Australian Oaks double, after Pennyweka (Satono Aladdin) in 2023, Bonneval in 2017 (Makfi), and Domino (Grosvenor) in 1990. **Continued on page 2**

Sir Delius lands biggest career success in QEII as Autumn Glow's run comes to an end

Sir Delius (Frankel) - the headline horse of the spring for reasons good and bad - proved his rare quality beyond doubt in taking the Queen Elizabeth Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) as Autumn Glow's (The Autumn Sun) winning streak came to a decisive end at Randwick on Saturday. **Continued on page 4**

Continued from page 1 McDonald was at his coolest in making Ohope Wins the 14th Australian stakes winner for her Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m)-winning sire Ocean Park (Thorn Park), who stood at Waikato Stud last year for \$15,000 (plus GST).

Behind a strong pace set by longshot Stand My Ground (North Pacific), the field strung out such that Ohope Wins was some 15 lengths off the pace in second-last spot at the 900 metres. Meanwhile, Profoundly (Farnan), second

favourite at \$3.20, seemingly held a distinct advantage, travelling fifth, two lengths off a breakaway group.

Profoundly duly took the lead under Tommy Berry over the rise, but behind and to her outside, Ohope Wins was building a formidable head of steam down the centre of the track.

To her credit, Profoundly battled gamely all the way down the straight, but Ohope Wins was able to outstay her, taking the lead 60 metres out and scoring by a half-length.

Dom Sutton's After Summer (The Autumn Sun), who so nearly pinched the Vinery at \$61, showed it was no fluke in running a close third at \$9.50.

Savouring his 196th Group 1 success, expat Kiwi Waller paid tribute to Ohope Wins' previous New Zealand trainers Lance O'Sullivan and Andrew Scott for the progress of the filly, who was subject to a majority buy-in from Yulong in January.

"I can't take all the credit," Waller said.

"Obviously, I've been trusted by Yulong. Lance O'Sullivan did a great job with her prior to coming to me plus they gave me a hand with her as well. Very friendly and very helpful which we've got to thank them for."

Waller said inheriting such a proven performer had been "not hard at all because you know the horse is good enough."

"It was just about keeping it simple," he said. "Maybe we got it a little bit simple first-up [in the Vinery]; I think she just needed the run."

"Speaking with Lance O'Sullivan, the confidence he had in her - he said she's one of the best horses that he's ever had to deal with, so it's a pretty big comment coming from him."

Celebrating his 135th Group 1 success, McDonald said Ohope Wins relished the genuine pace.

"They ran it really quickly so it suited her down to the ground," he said.

"Obviously, on paper it didn't look that way, but I always had a plan to ride her quiet. I was blessed when the pace **Continued on page 4**

Continued from page 2 went on and it never stopped so it was going to be the toughest stayer, and that's exactly what she was.

"It didn't go well last start [in the Vinery], Rosehill, slowly run race.

"She's gritty, she's a very gritty filly. She had enough on the line, the other two [placegetters] were brave and it was lucky we were on a good horse."

Ohope Wins immediately put herself in the reckoning for spring staying highlights such as the Caulfield Cup (Gr 1, 2400m) and Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m).

McDonald, however, said a staying future was not necessarily a fait accompli for the filly.

While he said "2400 metres is a good number for her" he added: "But you never know. As they get stronger some of them get quicker, so she might get quicker."

Bred by Gartshore Bloodstock, Ohope Wins is the fourth and best of four named foals for the Australian-placed mare Choux Mania (Redoute's Choice) - the first three of whom are unplaced - and is the only one not put through a public sale.

Choux Mania is a three-quarter sister to elite winner Miss Wilson (Stratum) and a half-sister to five-time Group 1 victor Jimmy Choux (Thorn Park).

She now has two-year-old and yearling full-brothers to Ohope Wins. She lost her foal by Noverre (Savabeel) in 2025, before being covered by that stallion again.

Ocean Park has 26 stakes winners worldwide from 614 runners at 4.23 per cent.

Sir Delius lands biggest career success in QEII as Autumn Glow's run comes to an end

Sir Delius (Frankel) - the headline horse of the spring for reasons good and bad - proved his rare quality beyond doubt in taking the Queen Elizabeth Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) as Autumn Glow's (The Autumn Sun) winning streak came to a decisive end at Randwick on Saturday.

Imported to Australia after a Group 3 win and an elite placing from six starts in France, Sir Delius was a sensation of 2025, with victory in Doomben's Chairman's Handicap (Gr 3, 2000m) on his Australian debut followed by imposing spring victories in Caulfield's Underwood Stakes (Gr 1, 1800m) and Flemington's Turnbull Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m).

But as a dominant favourite for the Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) and Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m), he was sensationally ordered out of the remainder of the carnival by Racing Victoria vets, due to unfavourable bone scans.

However, rebooted for the autumn by trainers Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott, the five-year-old entire hinted he'd retained his spring sparkle with thirds in Randwick's Verry Elleegant Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) - behind Autumn Glow - and second-up in the Ranvet Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m), won by Aeliana (Castelvecchio).

And while most of the Australian racing community will have been cheering for the 11-from-11 Autumn Glow to remain unbeaten on Saturday - not least those who took her \$1.31 starting price - the doubts surrounding her first try beyond 1600 metres proved vindicated, **Continued on page 5**

Continued from page 4 and it was Sir Delius who pounced on her vulnerability.

Sir Delius, Sir Owen Glenn's \$6 second elect, was masterfully ridden by Craig Williams who, if Autumn Glow's partner and Australian Group 1 record holder James McDonald is the country's No.1, can't be far behind in second.

Williams, and his training collaborators, knew they had to be in front of Autumn Glow in the run, for if doubts about her 2000-metre capabilities were to prove justified, they would be put to a stern test if asked to chase down a proven middle-distance performer of Sir Delius' class.

And thus it transpired in a tactical affair, and one somewhat surprising. William Haggas's raider Dubai Honour (Pride Of Dubai), who boldly led last start over longer and was just caught by Aeliana in the Tancred Stakes (Gr 1, 2400m), this time took a sit, midfield of the seven, as \$7.50 third favourite.

Lindermann (Lonhro), who usually leads, this time sat last under the wily Nash Rawiller, at \$31.

And Aeliana, felt by many to pose perhaps the most serious threat to stablemate Autumn Glow, took no position at all. Trainer Chris Waller scratched her on race morning, saying she wasn't as sharp as he'd have hoped in her work through the week.

As last-start Australian Cup (Gr 1, 2000m) winner Light Infantry Man (Fast Company) led under an even pace, Williams was right where he wanted to be, four lengths off him in fourth, with Autumn Glow three lengths further behind.

The pace picked up from the 800 metres

and Williams easily sent his mount forward, eventually taking the lead entering the straight.

Autumn Glow ranged up behind, and the crowd was set alight. But as she shaped for her usual charge to the line, worrying signs appeared. Asked for her effort, she veered out at the 350 metres, and veered back in again soon after, her action far rougher than usual. The distance was indeed telling.

In front of her, Sir Delius was bullet straight, under hands and heels riding from Williams, and full of running. Two reminders with the whip at the 150 metres put the issue beyond doubt, and Sir Delius scored a thoroughly deserved win, by 2.2 lengths.

Lindermann showed the benefits of his new tactics in working home well for second,

relegating the tiring Autumn Glow into third a further 0.3 lengths away.

Purchased by Sir Owen's Go Bloodstock, De Burgh Equine, Waterhouse-Bott and McKeever Bloodstock at the 2024 Tattersals Autumn Horses in Training Sale at Newmarket for 1.3 million guineas, Sir Delius has now earned his new owners \$4.49 million in seven Australian starts.

He took home \$3.06 million from the \$5 million Queen Elizabeth, providing a second win in the race for Williams and Sir Owen after the 2015 victory of Criterion (Sebring).

And his trainers were delighted to have won a bonafide Australian major, essentially at his first realistic time of asking following his late spring scratching dramas. **Cont. on page 6**

"This is the one that counted," said Adrian Bott, dubbing Sir Delius a "once in a lifetime horse".

"Obviously it was difficult in the first parts of the preparation. He had a little bit of expectation on him from what he was able to achieve in the spring.

"But we kept focus and this was the goal that we really wanted to be able to achieve. Today was the right set-up and Craig executed it perfectly.

"We were a little bit negative last start. Sir Owen gave Craig the rev up he maybe needed today and he's come out and responded like champions do and he's given a beauty [of a ride]."

Bott said the race was "always going to be a tactical affair" considering his team were taking on Autumn Glow.

"We did want to be in front of her, though I always felt it wasn't going to be necessarily us making the pace," he said.

"It was unfolding really well. Travelling into the straight I thought we were in a great position."

Asked about the disappointments of the horse's scratching in Melbourne last spring, Bott said: "We move forward. You've got to look at those targets in front of you. I'm delighted he's been able to get back to the top level. He's executed really well and I can't wait for the spring again."

Bott has won two Golden Slippers (Gr 1, 1200m) since teaming with Waterhouse, but said winning the Queen Elizabeth was on a par, particularly given the pressures of training an expensive import.

"It's got to be right up there. Obviously the weight of these types of horses, that does weigh on you throughout the preparation," he said.

"Coming here today against a champion mare [Autumn Glow] as well, it's one of the biggest races we've been able to win as a partnership, so it's certainly right up there.

"Once in a lifetime horses are difficult to come across."

McDonald said Autumn Glow was "brave in defeat".

"They really stretched it from basically the 1400 metres," he said. "She relaxed and travelled into it beautifully. Credit to the winner. He sustained that speed. He was up there fighting and too good on the day."

Celebrating his 90th Group 1 win, Williams said he was privileged to be able to partner Sir Delius.

"I was lucky enough to get invited to this horse when they first purchased him for a Melbourne Cup path and what we had with him

in the spring was just amazing," he said.

"Then, they brought him back in the autumn. The trainers and owners had so much challenges with what happened in the spring."

Still, Williams was left to praise Waterhouse-Bott for their work with the stallion this preparation, after the jockey had been less than impressed with one recent trackwork session.

"I said, 'Look, the horse is going really well, [but] he's not fast enough,'" Williams said. "A week later I said, 'You've done a fantastic job'."

"In the spring, he was flying; he was airborne. The only time I've felt that since then was last Tuesday morning. What an amazing racehorse."

Williams also paid tribute, with a smile, to Sir Delius's professionalism as a racehorse, despite his stallion status.

"In the gates, he had Autumn Glow next to him and he was giving her a look," he said. "I said, 'If you win this, you've got a chance of dating her.'"

Sir Delius has always had a price tag commensurate with his regal bloodlines.

Breeders David and Trish Brown of Furnace Mill Stud sold him to Coolmore's MV Magnier for 675,000gns at the Tattersalls December Foal Sale in 2021.

His dam, Whatami (Daylami), has bred five winners and three stakes victors among eight runners. His siblings include his Wolferton Stakes (Listed, 1m 2f) winning full-brother Juan Elcano and the Group 3-winning Nkosikazi (Cape Cross).

The 20-year-old Whatami is a sister to Group 2 winner James Garfield's (Exceed And Excel) dam Whazzat, Continued on page 7

Continued from page 6 who in turn is the second dam of another Group 2 victor in Wimbledon Hawkeye (Kameko).

Sire Delius is one of 173 stakes winners globally for Juddmonte's super sire Frankel (Galileo), from 1,042 runners at a phenomenal 16.6 per cent.

Frankel has 21 stakes winners in Australia including four at the elite level, a quartet also including Australian-breds Hungry Heart and Converge, and British import Mirage Dancer.

Still only 17, Frankel has 40 Group 1 winners worldwide.

Smith's Flyer nothing like Idle as she lands huge Group 1 in Queen Of The Turf

Underrated filly Idle Flyer (Dundeel) gave more proof her sire's gender tide was turning by upsetting a supposed three-horse race to score her elite breakthrough in Saturday's Queen Of The Turf Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m).

The \$1 million Randwick feature was promoted as a clash of three star mares. Chris Waller's Lady Shenandoah (Snitzel) started favourite at \$3.50, marginally ahead of Matt Laurie's Treasurethe Moment (Alabama Express) at \$3.80 and Ciaran Maher's Pride Of Jenni (Pride Of Dubai) at \$4.

But it was Idle Flyer - from the boutique Warwick Farm stable of Matt Smith and a \$6 fourth elect - who stole the show in the fillies and mares' event.

The four-year-old wasn't without her backers, firming from \$6.50 in light of her previous start victory in Rosehill's Emancipation Stakes (Gr 2, 1500m), and

she rewarded their faith with a thoroughly professional display.

Pride Of Jenni set the pace, of course, and held a Pride Of Jenni-like five-length lead passing the 800 metres. But perhaps sapped by her heroic near-stealing of the Australian Cup (Gr 1, 2000m) two weeks earlier, this would not be her day. She ended up on the bottom of the highly rated three, weakening in the straight to finish fifth.

James McDonald on Lady Shenandoah had the job of taking the field up to Pride Of Jenni before the turn, while Treasurethe Moment stalked her in third.

But while Lady Shenandoah and Treasurethe Moment made their runs after

straightening, it was Idle Flyer behind those two who was travelling the strongest.

Set loose by Zac Lloyd, she had a battle with Lady Shenandoah for 100 metres, but gained the ascendancy in the last 50 to beat her by 0.9 lengths.

Treasurethe Moment held third, a further 0.8 lengths away.

Sold by breeders Torryburn Stud to Smith and Randwick Bloodstock for just \$70,000 at Inglis Classic in 2023, Idle Flyer has now earned \$1.27 million from 15 starts for eight wins. Saturday's was her third stakes victory in a neat progression, having first earned black type in October's Angst Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m) at Randwick.

"I just can't believe she's won. I knew she was going good but I didn't think she'd win that so we'll take it," said Smith after his sixth elite success.

"It was a proper Group 1. We've got a great crew in the horse and great supporters of the stable. It's what we get up in the morning for, it means a lot to us.

"She's always looked like she'd run a strong mile here and you need to be able to run a strong mile to win one of these good mile races. You've got to be able to run further probably.

"When she won here last time here over the mile we thought this was the race for her. It was just a matter of getting here fit and well."

Smith was full of praise for the 22-year-old Lloyd, who also completed a sixth Group 1 win.

"I was happy he was on the back of the right horses," Smith said. "The three to beat were in front of us. We were just hoping that Pride Of Jenni had a bad day and we were able to get home over the top of them."

Lloyd has built a superb association with Idle Flyer, riding her eight times for seven wins, including all three stakes races.

"Fantastic to win on her. I love her as a horse and that just shows in our record together," he said. "For her to go into that race, it was a proper horse race against the best milers in the country. They've got a proper horse on their hands.

"She can travel at a high speed. Obviously that's the key when you're versing [racing against] Pride Of Jenni. I got a lovely run today in behind Lady Shenandoah and Treasurethe Moment. I was in the perfect spot at the 600 and my horse delivered.

"I'm very happy to get the Group 1 for Matt [Smith] because I love riding for Matt and he's been a good supporter of me."

With Idle Flyer only three runs into her campaign, Smith said he may push on to the Brisbane carnival, with the Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1400m) in mind.

Lloyd, however, feels the mare would be better suited over longer.

"I actually said to Matt when she was trialling back in this prep, 'this filly could probably get further now,'" Lloyd said.

"She's just started to mature and relax. Today was probably the most she's been in the bridle, so Matt had her nice and fresh for the occasion and wasn't worried about her pulling with having Pride Of Jenni in the race. But I'm sure Matt will figure it out."

Idle Flyer is the fifth foal out of Progressive (Street Cry), a Sydney city winner of four races from the uber-successful American-bred family of her third dam Dancing Show (Nijinsky), and that mare's granddam Best In Show (Traffic Judge).

Progressive's yearling filly by Harry Angel

(Dark Angel) was bought from Torryburn by Broodmares P.L. at this year's Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale for \$200,000. She now has a weanling colt by Tassort (Brazen Beau), and was not covered last spring.

Idle Flyer became the tenth Group 1 winner for Dundee (High Chaparral), who stood at Arrowfield Stud last spring for \$88,000 (inc GST).

While Dundee's sons made virtually all the early running for the stallion on the track, his daughters have been addressing that gender imbalance of late.

Dundee's 40 stakes winners include 26 sons, but of his ten Australian black type victors last season, seven were female.

Of his past 14 stakes victories, fillies and mares have accounted for 12, while his past two top-tier winners now have been female, with Idle Flyer joining last season's SA Derby (Gr 1, 2500m) heroine Femminele.

Dundee's stakes winners come from 735 runners at 5.44 per cent.

Percy Sykes plan for Team Archibald's Bomshell works out

Cherry Bomshell (Lucky Vega) became her sire's second Australian black type winner with an upset victory in Saturday's Percy Sykes Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) for two-year-old fillies at Randwick.

Well ridden by visiting Brisbane-based regular partner Ben Thompson, Cherry Bomshell settled second-last of the nine while Thompson let a small squadron battle for the lead.

Continued from page 8 The Team Archibald-trained filly was full of momentum inside the straight while the leaders were tiring but couldn't see clear galloping room as the Team Hayes/Godolphin \$3.90 favourite Medicinal (Brazen Beau) took what looked a commanding lead.

But once she was clear at the 200 metres, Thompson pulled the pin on Cherry Bomshell's pent up energy and she exploded in a devastating finish, surging to the line to beat Medicinal by 0.8 lengths.

Ciaron Maher's Ciaron's Star (I Am Invincible) gained her first dash of black type, running a further 0.6 lengths behind in third at \$21.

While Medicinal went into the race after winning Flemington's Ottawa Stakes (Gr 3, 1000m) at her third start, Cherry Bomshell claimed her first black type with the victory.

Starting off in Team Archibald's Brisbane stable, she'd proven herself worthy of an ambitious trip south by winning her second and third starts over 1000 metres at Eagle Farm, the first of those a 6.7-length maiden romp on February 4. But in her first start since February 28 - with a Warwick Farm barrier trial win in between - punters were content to let her drift from \$15 to start at \$17.

However, Annabel Archibald, who co-trains with husband Rob, said the win wasn't out of the blue. The stable had entertained thoughts of a Golden Slipper (Gr 1, 1200m) attempt with the filly, but demurred due to what would have been a busy Sydney schedule required to earn a start.

Archibald was delighted with the value boost that came in the prestigious Sykes instead for Cherry Bomshell, who races in Australian Bloodstock's colours.

Asked if she was surprised, she said: "Not really. She's always been so progressive.

"We'd actually half-hoped we'd get her into a Slipper, but we weren't going to chase. We would've had to go through the Magic Night and we would've run three times in four weeks so we left it alone and came here.

"We had a chat with the Australian Bloodstock crew and they were keen with that plan. It worked out well and I'm glad we decided to fly Ben Thompson down.

"It was a big cheer when she crossed the line. Lovely ride from Ben. It was a tricky draw so ultimately we left it up to him. We weren't sure there was a whole lot of speed but we were just adamant we didn't want her caught wide. He just bided his time and she's just a beautiful, straightforward filly."

She added: "A big shout out to the

Queensland team up at Eagle Farm because she's actually had most of her prep up there. They've done a great job with her. She's a long time in between runs, first time at the 1200 metres, but she trialled very well and she's now a very valuable Percy Stakes winner."

Thompson said the win was a plan well executed.

"She's a lovely filly," he said. "It's so hard to line these horses up in the same state let alone crossing states. I just thought this was always her race.

"The Golden Slipper was a dream ... but it wasn't to be. Here was always the plan. She was coming here six weeks [between runs]. It was calculated and she nailed it.

"She was a bit keen early, even going to the gates. I had ridden her in her last two, and she was more casual. But I felt once we joined them at the course proper she was going as I wanted her to and it just panned out perfect."

Yulong's eight-year-old shuttler Lucky Vega (Lope De Vega) made an exceptional start to stud life in Australia last season when his first runner in the country became a stakes winner. Within The Law claimed Flemington's Inglis Banner (RL, 1000m) amid two stakes victories and a Group 1 second in her first season.

But Yulong had to wait until Saturday for the stallion's second Australian black type victor, although New Zealand colt That's Gold won at Group 3 and Group 2 level in his home country over the summer.

Lucky Vega, who stood last year for \$38,500 (inc GST) - up from \$16,500 - now has four stakes winners worldwide from 111 runners. In Australia, has had two from 47 and 24 winners.

Cherry Bomshell is the fifth foal out of the city-placed mare Not A Cherry (Not A Single Doubt), whose dam Cherokee Echo (Cherokee Run) won in Listed class in the US.

Older half-brother Rhythm Of Love (Grunt) is a dual Sydney city winner who's been Group 3 placed in Brisbane.

Not A Cherry missed in 2024 but now has a weanling colt by Yulong's Grunt (O'Reilly) and was covered again by Lucky Vega last spring.

Bred by Yulong, Cherry Bomshell was sold from the stud's draft at the 2025 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale to Australian Bloodstock and Archibald Racing for \$220,000.

Ten for Dundeel

Idle Flyer (4 m ex Progressive by Street Cry) delivered a landmark tenth individual Group 1 winner for Dundeel (High Chaparral) with victory in the Queen Of The Turf Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) at Randwick on Saturday. A \$70,000 Inglis Classic Sale Purchase, by her trainer Mathew Smith Racing and Randwick Bloodstock Agency from the draft of Torryburn Stud she has now earned her connections \$1,272,925. Idle Flyer is out of Progressive (Street Cry), herself a sister to Transfers, who herself is the dam of three individual stakes winners that includes two-time Group 1 winner Tom Kitten (Harry Angel). The family traces back to third dam Twyla (Danehill), a daughter of the

influential Dancing Show (Nijinsky), with this branch responsible for elite performers such as Gathering (Tale Of The Cat), Desert Lightning (Pride Of Dubai), In Italian (Dubawi) and You Wahng (So You Think), further enhancing Idle Flyer's profile as a valuable future broodmare. Dundeel stood the 2025 breeding season for a fee of \$88,000 (inc GST).

104 for Galileo

Changingoftheguard (7 g ex Lady Lara by Excellent Art) delivered a 104th individual Group 1 winner for Galileo (Sadler's Wells) with a determined staying performance in the Sydney Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) at Randwick. The Kris Lees-trained gelding defied his \$51 quote with a bold display under Jason Collett, dictating throughout and holding off Soul Of Spain (Phoenix Of Spain) by 0.3 lengths, with Highland Bling (Highland Reel) the same distance further back in third. Collett's ride proved decisive, allowing the stayer to control the tempo before responding under pressure. "It's a good feeling when a horse gets in a good rhythm like that. We don't get too many opportunities here in Australia over these distances," Collett said. Lees, who won the race 20 years earlier with County Tyrone (Danewin), added: "I would have to say this is just as big a thrill... it's a great thrill to win in those colours too." A former Aidan O'Brien-trained galloper,

Changingoftheguard was a Group 2 winner at Royal Ascot before transferring to Australia, where he has been patiently developed by Lees. His Sydney Cup success followed a solid ninth in last spring's Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m), 9.9 lengths behind Half Yours (St Jean). Out of the Group 2-winning mare Lady Lara, who is also the dam of Listed winner Chantez (Wootton Bassett), he adds further depth to Galileo's legacy as a dominant influence on elite performers worldwide. Galileo died in 2021.

Five for Lucky Vega

Cherry Bomshell (2 f ex Not A Cherry by Not A Single Doubt) became the fifth individual stakes winner for Yulong shuttler Lucky Vega (Lope De Vega) when she made amends for missing a start in the Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) with a lucrative victory in the \$1 million Percy Sykes Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) on Day 2 of The Championships at Randwick on Saturday. Trainers Annabel and Rob Archibald were disappointed that the Yulong Investments-bred graduate didn't qualify for the Golden Slipper but Saturday's \$580,000 pay-day was a more than an adequate reward for Australian Bloodstock's Luke Murell and Jamie Lovett. A \$220,000 Magic Millions purchase from Yulong for Australian Bloodstock and Neasham & Archibald Racing, Cherry Bomshell was bred by

Yulong and is a half-sister to the Group-placed Rhythm Of Love (Grunt) and is the second winner from four to race from Not A Cherry (Not A Single Doubt), herself out of US stakes winner Cherokee Echo (Cherokee Run). Not a Cherry was covered again last spring by Lucky Vega after producing a colt by Grunt (O'Reilly). Lucky Vega stood the 2025 breeding season for a fee of \$38,500 (inc GST).

31 for Brazen Beau

Promising colt Diameter (2 c ex Circular by Street Cry) scored an on-pace victory in the Fernhill Mile (Listed, 1600m) at Randwick on Saturday to become the 31st stakes winner for Darley stallion Brazen Beau (I Am Invincible). Ridden by Tommy Berry, Diameter defeated Salann (Shamus Award) by 0.9 lengths with a further 1.2 lengths back to Don't Look Back (Saxon Warrior) in third. He's also the third Godolphin-bred Fernhill winner in the last four years following Broadsiding (Too Darn Hot) and Tom Kitten (Harry Angel). Trainer Chris Waller was happy to open Day 2 of The Championships on a winning note while acknowledging Diameter can develop into a classy horse next season. "I trained Brazen Beau and know a bit about them," he said. "He's always shown us that he will get a mile so we came here confident." Waller indicated Diameter will back-up off a seven-day turnaround in the Champagne Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) next Saturday. Diameter is the fourth winner from five foals to race out of the Group 3-winning Street Cry (Machiavellian) mare Circular, who traces back to the family of champion racehorse and sire Lonhro (Octagonal), making him a half-brother to Newmarket Handicap (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Cylinder (Exceed And Excel) and Group winner Parisal (Astern). Circular has not had a live foal since Diameter, but was covered last spring by Too Darn Hot (Dubawi). Brazen Beau stood the 2025 breeding season at a fee of \$27,500 (inc GST).

Tempted targets The Everest following Sprint success

Brilliant Godolphin homebred Tempted (3 f Street Boss - Calliope by Exceed And Excel) broke the Randwick class record for 1200 metres with a scintillating victory in the Arrowfield 3YO Sprint (Gr 2, 1200m) at The Championships on Saturday. Starting a \$1.60 favourite, the Street Boss (Street Cry) filly let loose with a dazzling turn of foot at the furlong pole to score by 1.2 lengths from Devil Night (Extreme Choice). She clocked 68 seconds to better the previous mark of 68.14 seconds set by Cosmic Force (Deep Field). Tempted remains unbeaten this campaign and her connections are already looking forward to a rematch with Hong Kong superstar Ka Ying Rising (Shamexpress) in this year's The Everest (Gr 1, 1200m). "She just keeps raising the bar," trainer Ciaran Maher said. "She has a brilliant turn of foot and came into our stable in super order from James [Cummings]. Each time she runs she furnishes and develops. Her run in the Everest last year was huge and I'm just so thrilled to be able to train for Godolphin and thrilled for my team." Maher described Chad Schofield's effort as a "cool, calm, collected ride" but the jockey said Tempted made his job easy. "She can be wherever you want her to be," Schofield said. "She can be forward, back, relax and then access that turn of foot. It's really breathtaking and she feels amazing." Classique Legend (Not A Single Doubt) won the Arrowfield Sprint in 2019 and returned the following spring to claim The Everest.

In Flight back to winning form in Sapphire Stakes

Flying Artie (Artie Schiller) mare In Flight (5 m Flying Artie - Waveline by Stravinsky) added another stakes success to her resume, recording her ninth career win in the Sapphire Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) at Randwick. The Joe Pride-trained mare produced a strong performance under Craig Williams, settling

ideally before asserting late to defeat Infancy (Wandjina) by 0.8 lengths, with Gangsta Granny (Written Tycoon) a further 0.2 lengths back in third. "It's a huge result, she's a lovely little mare who keeps getting better with age and I think there's more wins in store," Pride said. While there was a query on the dry track, she ticked that box and In Flight looks set to travel north to Brisbane with targets like the Victory Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) as a lead-up to the Doomben 10,000 (Gr 1, 1200m). Pride added: "This is her time of year, this is when she really thrived last time. Last year she won three stakes races in three different states all in a row. She's a very tough durable mare who will handle the racing, looking for some wet tracks around the place although she's won on the dry today so very pleased with that."

Beskar bound for Brisbane after South Pacific win

Snitzel (3 g Snitzel - Sword Of Light by New Approach) gelding Beskar booked a trip to Brisbane after landing the South Pacific Classic (Listed, 1400m) at Randwick for Victorian trainers Anthony and Sam Freedman. It was his second black-type victory on the bounce as a \$5.50 second-favourite on Saturday in contrast to an \$81 boiler in the Darby Munro Stakes (Listed, 1200m) at Rosehill last month. "He's become genuine and handles this direction so the winter carnival is probably the logical step," Anthony Freedman said. "He's always shown ability but just lost his way and needed gelding. He can sustain a long gallop and that opens up options at 1400 metres." Winning jockey Damian Lane admitted he's hardly straightforward. "The more you tell him to do something he doesn't want to do, he works against you," Lane said. "It was a free-flowing win today so I just went with him and luckily he held on." Beskar was bred and sold by Widden Stud for \$600,000 at the 2024 Inglis Easter Yearling Sale to Pinecliff Racing's Jonathan Munz.

Lord Of Biscay leads home Lees quinella in Championship Final

Lord Of Biscay (Lope De Vega) delivered another major success for Kris Lees, the Irish-bred gelding proving too strong for the local talent when taking out the Provincial-Midway Championships Final (1400m) at Randwick, with the trainer sending out the quinella in the race. The result mirrored last year's trifecta in a different order, with last year's runner-up Lord Of Biscay surging clear once into the open to defeat his stablemate Imposant (Epaulette) by three lengths, and defending titleholder Matcha Latte (Maurice) a further 0.6 lengths behind in third. The winner enjoyed a "perfect run in transit" according to his trainer who said: "I was very confident in the run with him... he was getting all the favours he needed, and he reacted well," with the victory marking his sixth success in the race. We're the biggest stable in the provincials, we're entitled to have a good representation, but full credit to all the staff at home to get these horses presented on the day and they raced really well." Jockey James McDonald added: "Kris is a champion... he knows how to 'prep' these horses up... he's in career-best form, and he felt enormous today." He is now likely to head to the Tamworth Cup (1400m) on April 24 in the hope to qualify him for the Big Dance (1600m) at Randwick on Melbourne Cup day, a race he finished seventh in last year.

32 for Brazen Beau

Mating Call (3 f ex Monopole by High Chaparral) became the 32nd individual stakes winner for Brazen Beau with victory in the Auraria Stakes (Gr 3, 1800m) at Morphettville on Saturday, continuing her upward trajectory this preparation. The progressive homebred filly has now won twice and placed at Group level, showing steady development. Trained by Dan Clarcken & Oopy MacGillivray, Mating Call defeated Freedom Flame (Ghaiyyath) by a half-

length with a further 3.8 lengths back to Naraghi (Hello Youmzain) in third. The win bucks the trend for Brazen Beau, whose progeny usually prove more dominant over shorter trips, with her pedigree offering a clear explanation through her dam Monopole (High Chaparral), a three-time winner from 1400 metres to 2100 metres and also being Listed-placed in the Tasmanian Oaks (2100m) that is from the family of Group 3 winner Raise (Arena) and Australian Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) heroine Rena's Lady (Arena). Mating Call rounded out a stakes double for Brazen Beau alongside Diameter, who secured Listed honours at Randwick.

Verzain (2 f ex Written Verse by Written Tycoon) became the fifth individual stakes winner for her sire Zousain (Zoustar) with a determined victory in the Without Fear Stakes (Listed, 1050m) at Morphettville on Saturday. The Phillip Stokes-trained filly showed tenacity under Jacob Opperman when breaking her maiden in the Listed contest, taking control late before holding off Ole Go (Ole Kirk) by 0.4 lengths, with Czech Out (Prague) a further 0.8 lengths away in third. A \$40,000 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale purchase from Goodwood Farm, Verzain has now won and placed at stakes level from just three starts, underlining her early progression. From a relatively light immediate pedigree, she gains depth through her dam Written Verse, a daughter of Written Tycoon (Iglesia), with the family tracing to dual Group 1 winner and sire Extreme Choice (Not A Single Doubt). Zousain

stood the 2025 breeding season at Widden Stud for a fee of \$27,500 (inc GST).

Six for Alabama Express

McWoody (3 c ex Queen Ouija by Street Cry) became the sixth individual stakes winner for Yulong stallion Alabama Express (Redoute's Choice) with victory in the Port Adelaide Guineas (Listed, 1800m) at Morphettville on Saturday. McWoody, a winner at his previous start at Sandown, was too strong under Daniel Stackhouse as he defeated Bootlegger (Too Darn Hot) by 1.1 lengths. There was a further 0.3 lengths back to Cannae (Maurice) in third place and now looks firmly on a South Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2500m) path for his trainers. Bred on a highly effective cross, Alabama Express has produced ten winners from 12 runners with Street Cry-line mares, including Group 1 star Treasurethe Moment, underlining the potency of the nick. Bred by Yulong Stud and trained by Melbourne Cup-winning trainers John Symons and Sheila Laxon, the progressive colt continued his rise through the middle-distance ranks, bringing up his third win from just six starts this preparation. A \$27,500 Magic Millions Adelaide Yearling Sale purchase, McWoody represents a strong return for connections and further highlights the depth emerging from Alabama Express' early crops. Mcwoody has added value to his dam Queen Ouija (Street Cry), whose progeny include St Leger (Listed, 2600m) winner Dunwoody (Preferment), and who was again served by Alabama Express in 2025. Alabama Express stood the 2025 breeding season at a fee of \$66,000 (inc GST).

Two for King's Legacy

Regeneration became the second stakes winner for King's Legacy (Redoute's Choice) with victory in the Redelva Stakes (Listed, 1100m) at Morphettville on Saturday, continuing his consistent rise through the sprinting ranks. The Anthony and Sam Freedman-trained gelding, who had placed in all five prior starts,

King's Legacy stood for \$16,500 (inc GST) in 2025.

Super Smink lands seventh stakes win in R N Irwin

Dan Morton opted to travel east again with his five-year-old mare and was rewarded with another top-level performance, as Super Smink (5 m Super One - Sminky Shorts by Snitzel) recorded her seventh stakes victory when knocking off the favorite to win the R N Irwin Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) at Morphettville. The Western Australian star produced a dazzling last-to-first surge to defeat Watchme Win (Harry Angel) by 0.3 lengths, with Stretan Angel (Harry Angel) a further 1.7 lengths away in third, stamping her claims for upcoming targets such as the Robert Sangster Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m). A \$45,000 Magic Millions Perth Yearling Sale purchase, she continues to be a flagship performer for her sire who relocated to Roselee Park, Western Australia in 2024.

Arran Bay all heart in City Of Adelaide Handicap win

The choice to run seven-year-old gelding Arran Bay (All Too Hard) in the City Of Adelaide Handicap (Listed, 1529m) at Morphettville on Saturday was rewarded as he delivered another tough performance when carrying top weight

to claim the Listed contest. The Philip Stokes-trained All Too Hard (Casino Prince) gelding proved to be the better on the day under jockey Lachlan Neindorf, defeating Cash (Snitzel) by 0.5 lengths, with Chicago Storm (Trust In A Gust) a further 3.1 lengths off him in third. Opting for the Adelaide assignment over a Caulfield alternative, the decision proved well judged as a seasoned campaigner added a second listed success this campaign, having also taken out the C S Hayes Memorial Cup (Gr 3, 1600m) at the same track last month. A proven performer in strong company, Arran Bay now boasts 11 wins and over \$1 million in prize-money.

Al Duca (5 g ex Sienna Sunrise by Bertolini) defied the wet conditions and a Soft 7 surface for a determined victory in the Anniversary Vase (Listed, 1600m) at a rain-swept Caulfield on Saturday. The Mornington-based gelding completed a feature double for trainers Anthony and Sam Freedman after their earlier strike with Beskar in the South Pacific Classic at Randwick as he defeated Taken (Ardrossan) by 0.2 lengths, with a further 1.2 lengths back to Cilacap (Written Tycoon) in third. Al Duca is a homebred for Barb and Barry Saunders along with Rebecca Chidley and he became the 41st stakes winner by former Emirates Park sire Al Maher (Danehill), who died in 2024.

He's one of seven winners from NZ-bred mare Sienna Sunrise (Bertolini) and she is a half-sister to Group 3 winner San Bernardino (Gold Mine). "He just loves winning," the Freedmans posted on Facebook. "He handles the rugged conditions best and he also gave Luke a double."

Double Gin Twist at Caulfield

Coolmore Stud's new star stallion Home Affairs (I Am Invincible) sired Gin Twist (2 f Home Affairs - Twist Tops by Beneteau) to double-up in black-type ranks with an all-the-way victory in the Redoute's Choice Stakes (Listed, 1200m) at Caulfield on Saturday. Home Affairs sired Guest House to win the \$5 million Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) last month and he's home and hosed for the 2025-26 Australian First-Season Sires' Premiership. Gin Twist had won the Festival Stakes (Listed, 1000m) in February for Lindsay Park Bloodstock and she's already paid back a \$220,000 price-tag at the 2025 Magic Millions Gold Coast Sale. Will Hayes, who trains in partnership with brothers Ben & JD, said it was a pleasing result and justification to extend her campaign with Gin Twist lining up for her fifth career start. "It was a real professional effort," Hayes said. "We got her back to the farm to see how she did between runs and she franked the decision to come here today. Credit to Luke Currie. He summed up the race very well and let her relax in front in the early stages. Her ears were flicking at the top of the straight and we knew she had a kick left for the finish."

Single Choice set for SA Derby following Galilee win

Ballarat trainer Matt Cumani is gunning for his first Group 1 with Single Choice (3 g Anders - Sebring Sally by Sebring) on the back of a second black-type victory in the Galilee Series Final (Listed, 2400m) at Caulfield on Saturday. Single Choice won the Autumn Classic (Gr 2, 1800m) at Caulfield in February and the South

There was a further 0.2 lengths back to Amazake (Maurice) in third. "I was very nervous about whether he would get the trip but it was a beautiful ride by Motty," Cumani said. "There was no speed early but they went pretty solid from the 800 metres so he had to sustain a pretty hard run. We've got to go to Adelaide off that win. It may not have been a solidly run 2400 metres throughout but I think it was enough of a test to say that we can go over and give it a go." Mott was full of praise for Single Choice considering he had to come from back in the field to win the Autumn Classic. "It was a bit of a new scenario for him but he adapted well. If he takes that form into the Derby, they will know he's there for sure," he added.

Cavalry Scout too strong in Up & Coming Stars Series Final

Cavalry Scout (Blue Point) broke through for his maiden win in style, taking out the Up and Coming Series final (1400m) at Caulfield while adding another winner to Blue Point's (Shamardal) tally of winners. The Ciaron Maher-trained gelding, who had been competitive in all three prior starts, produced a front-running display under jockey Beau Mertens to score a 0.8-length victory over Ten Warriors (Saxon Warrior), with Santana (Ole Kirk) a further 0.4 lengths away in third. Assistant trainer Jack Turnbull told Racing.com: "He's got it done on the rich day with all the rich prize-money, because we thought he would have got his maiden out of the way a couple of times before today. He's been above average as we would

describe him, but he was making a liar of us there for a while. We ran second [at Sandown Lakeside] to qualify. We think the horse has a bright future, so we're delighted for him to get that win today. A homebred horse who is out of Colin and Janice's mare Girl Guide, that they raced. It's exactly why you race in these particular events because it's like winning a group race and that was essentially his maiden so it's a great result." The well-supported favourite Dirty Look (Super Seth) (\$2.30) settled back and was unable to make an impression in the straight, while Luke Currie, who guided Santana into third, claimed the series jockey's title on countback after finishing level on 18 points with Jamie Mott, rider of runner-up Ten Warriors.

Legends land latest WATC Derby

Williams Racing and Willie Pike are both in double-figures for wins in the WATC Derby (Gr 2, 2400m) and their latest classic was the easiest of them all courtesy of Sentimental Legend (3 g Brutal - Sentimental Star by More Than Ready) on Saturday. Sentimental Legend tracked WA Oaks (Gr 3, 2400m) winner Wonderfully Made (Playing God) and then put her away at the top of the straight before beating Tahni Talk (Maschino) by 2.1 lengths. There was a further 1.1 lengths back to Masmelo (Maschino) in third. "I was happy the way it unfolded after Lucy (Fiore) went to the front on the filly," Pike said. "He hit the front with a sustained burst and then pricked his ears and waited for them. We're nowhere near the bottom of him. Wait till he's 50 kilograms heavier in six or twelve months. I've always said you can get a good stayer to run a good race at a mile in a race like the Railway Stakes." Sentimental Legend is from the second crop of Newgate Farm sire Brutal (O'Reilly) and had won the Melvista Stakes (Listed, 2200m) earlier this month. He was bred by Grant and Alana Williams from Sentimental Star (More Than Ready) and is raced by Grant's sister Jodi

Howkins. "We're not kidding when we say Alana can breed a goodie and patience has proven key for Sentimental Legend," Williams Racing posted on Facebook. "We've always had high hopes for the three-year-old and our expectations are being matched."

Toa Haka too tough in Southern Alps final

Local runner Toa Haka (Iffraaj) claimed the biggest prize of his career when he made every post a winner in the \$350,000 TAB Southern Alps Challenge (1600m) at Riccarton on Saturday. The six-year-old son of Iffraaj (Zafonic) jumped well and took up pacemaking duties early under in-form apprentice Amber Riddell. Riddell dictated terms and had Toa Haka travelling powerfully rounding the home bend as they slipped clear by two lengths and asked the rest of the field to chase them down. Although visibly tiring in the last 50 metres, Toa Haka clung bravely to the lead and took the major spoils by 0.2 lengths from the late charging Sir Albert (Savabeel), Betty Spaghetti (Stratum Star) and Stonybreck (Tavistock) who finished virtually in a line behind him. Walsh was thrilled with the effort from a horse who has just kept on improving with age. "What a great result as he is such a genuine horse," trainer

David Walsh said. "He was quite immature when I got him and has just got stronger over time. He is very game and the best part about him is he gives it his all and knows where the finish line is. The plan today wasn't to lead but I always say to my jockeys that if no one else wants the front don't be afraid to go there as if you get beaten it is my fault not yours. Amber [Riddell] came back in and said that nobody really wanted to lead and when he jumped so well it seemed the right thing to do as he likes the track and is hard to get past when he is at his best. He has had three preps for us and when he has won for us he has won his next start as well, so when he is on he is really on."

Nine for Tarzino

Westbury Stud stallion Tarzino (Tavistock) was provided with his ninth individual stakes winner when Crouch (6 g ex Oya by Black Minnaloushe) scored in the Hawke's Bay Cup (Listed, 2200m) at Otaki on Saturday. Ridden by Chris Dell for trainer Mike Breslin, the six-year-old gelding defeated Sinhaman (Tivaci) by 1.7 lengths with a further 0.3 lengths back to Pacifico (Ardrossan) in third. "He is just coming of age if you look at his Wellington Cup run earlier and the Awapuni Cup run last time," Breslin said. "Today there was a bit more cut in the track and I said to Chris, who hadn't ridden him before, that the horse would maintain a gallop and that's what he did. I've pencilled in the Sandown Cup, which is a two-mile race in Aussie in late May, for him. He may be a touch below the top guns as there is also a two mile race at Flemington around the same time but you normally get all the imports in that as it is a qualifying event for the Melbourne Cup, so I think we will take him over for the Sandown Cup instead." A \$20,000 purchase by Breslin out of the Book 2 Westbury Stud draft at Karaka in 2021, Crouch is named after former Liverpool and English international footballer Peter Crouch and is raced by Breslin and Roy Potter. Out of the unraced Black Minnaloushe (Storm

Cat) mare Oya, Crouch is a half-brother to the stakes-placed winner Prince Alby (Sacred Falls). Tarzino stood the 2025 breeding season at a fee of \$25,000 (plus GST).

Platinum Attack all class in City Of Napier

A devastating home stretch sprint carried class galloper Platinum Attack (5 g Santos - Conchita by Uncle Mo) to an easy victory in the City Of Napier Sprint (Listed, 1200m) at Otaki. The Lisa Latta-prepared five-year-old is known as a lethal finisher when he gets conditions and a run to suit and the pieces to that puzzle fell into place perfectly for him in Saturday's feature short-course event on the programme. Rider Bruno Queiroz successfully negotiated a tricky wide barrier to have the son of Santos (I Am Invincible) travelling easily one off the fence midfield after just 300 metres as noted speedster Poetic Champion (Super Seth) set up a solid speed in front with race favourite Kitty Flash (Ace High) sitting on his flank throughout. Kitty Flash took over turning for home and momentarily looked like a winning proposition until Platinum Attack arrived on the scene in the middle of the track at the 200 metres. Queiroz let the handbrake off his mount and he charged clear to win easing down at the line by 1.2 lengths from topweight Navigator (El Roca), who had filled a similar placing when they clashed in the Lightning Handicap (Listed, 1200m) at Trentham last month, and Kitty Flash who fought bravely for her third placed finish, albeit six lengths astern of the winner. "The key to him is switching him off," Latta said. "The minute he gets up travelling a bit keen he can't quite finish it off and today they ran along at good speed which definitely helps. When he does switch off he has a blistering turn of foot. He has been in work all season long and has been competitive all the way and hasn't gone a bad race. We would love to try him at 1400 metres at some stage but we will let the dust settle from today before we make any decisions."

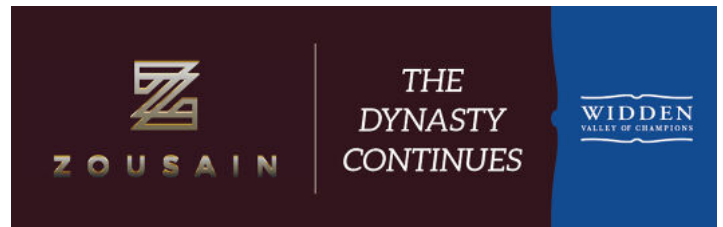

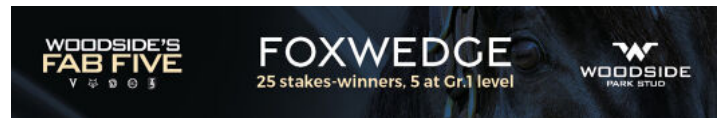
