# Kiwi-breds land another Classic as Wigmore wins South Australian Derby

New Zealand import Wigmore (Sweynesse) has been in work on both sides of the Tasman for six months but that didn't stop him motoring home for a narrow victory in the South Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2500m) at Morphettville on Saturday.

Wigmore was purchased by OTI director Terry Henderson from clients of trainer Caley Myers after finishing fourth to Road To Paris (Circus Maximus) in the New Zealand Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) at Ellerslie in March.

"Terry came up and told me he had 25 per

cent left so I put a few mates in which makes this a massive result," trainer Phillip Stokes said after the stable newcomer nailed VRC Oaks (Gr 1, 2500m) winner Strictly Business (Grunt) in a \$41 blow-out for punters.

Stokes was claiming back-to-back wins in the Classic following Femminile (Dundeel) who won with Lachie Neindorf aboard 12 months ago. Neindorf missed the ride this year but his dad Steve has a share in Wigmore.

"We just brought him along slowly. He ran midfield first-up for us in the Chairman's Stakes on Anzac Day and did an amazing job to win today," Stokes said. **Continued on page 3**

**Continued from page 2** “He didn’t even need a jump-out being such a clean-winded horse. He’s done really well in the last week and he’s a natural stayer. Who knows? In time we could have a Melbourne Cup horse.

“I’ve had a bit of luck with these types of horses like Daqiansweet Junior who was also from New Zealand. They can leave it on the track if you overtrain them.

“We’re getting up there now with nine Group 1 wins but don’t ask me what we do with him next. There’s the Queensland Derby but I’m not sure if I want to go that way.”

Stand-in jockey Teo Nugent rode a perfect race on the Soft 7 surface in Adelaide.

“He’s been trained to the minute and felt super when I was legged up,” the winning rider said.

“He’s a typical Kiwi and I switched off the heels of Kaye Jay into the straight and was confident bringing him down the middle of the track. He was only getting warm in the final stages and it took me a while to pull up.

“It’s my second Group 1 and it’s been a few years between drinks but it’s fitting to get one for Phil. I promised him when I was about 12 that I was going to be his apprentice.”

Wigmore’s progression through sales rings, is almost as impressive as his rapid rise to become a Group 1 winner at just his eighth start.

Originally offered online as a weanling in 2023 on Gavelhouse.com by Hallmark Stud, Wigmore was purchased by Ed Stapleton and Dylan Ralph of Ralph Thoroughbreds for just \$1700.

The pinhook paid dividends, with the colt being resold out of Book 2 of the 2024 NZB Karaka Sale for \$25,000 to Wanganui trainer Kevin Myers. Entering the stable of Caley Myers, Wigmore didn’t take long to show potential, winning at his third outing in January, with his rapid rise culminating for Myers with a fourth in the NZ Derby in March. This attracted the attention of OTI Racing and the gelding changed hands yet again, this time privately, resulting in a change of colours and country, and resulting in yesterday’s Group 1 victory.

He was bred by Karlene Murdoch and owns a stout pedigree as a half-brother to New Zealand Cup (Gr 3, 3200m) winner Mondorani (Burgundy).

Further down the page, his third-dam Arborea (Imperial Prince) was one of the best fillies of her generation at three winning the VRC Oaks, Wakeful Stakes (Gr 2, 2000m) and One Thousand Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) in the spring of 1993. **Continued on page 5**

## Wootton Bassett colt Excite leads home feature race quinella for James and Wellwood

The Roger James and Robert Wellwood stable were to the fore at Te Rapa on Saturday when progressive juveniles Excite (Wootton Bassett) and Incandescent (Per Incanto) produced a feature race quinella in the Waikato Equine Veterinary Centre Stakes (Listed, 1400m).

Wootton Bassett (Ifraaj) colt Excite was backed into \$2.75 favouritism for the contest off the back of an excellent run for fourth in the Manawatu Sires' Produce Sakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Trentham, and although he was still a maiden after three races in his opening campaign, he was expected to open his winning account on the weekend.

Rider George Rooke gave him the perfect run in the trail behind pacemakers Walkin In Memphis (Too Darn Hot) and Bourbon Time (Exceed And Excel) and it was obvious turning for home he had a lapful of horse if he could get a clear shot at the leaders.

Excite shouldered his way into the clear at the 250 metres and pounced on the leading

pair before easing a length clear as he hit the line full of running from his stablemate Incandescent, who had found clear air wider out and stormed into the runner-up position narrowly ahead of Bourbon Time and Walkin In Memphis, who both battled gamely after being headed.

James hinted a possible Australian campaign could be in the offing for Excite, who looks to have plenty of untapped potential.

"I think he [Excite] is a pretty fair horse in the making as we rode him a little conservatively at his last start because he is still a horse in the making," James said.

"We found out we could trust him and George rode him an absolute treat today and he duly delivered.

"The other horse [Incandescent] was good too as he made ground late to grab second, so we have a couple of smart horses looking towards the spring.

"We will see how they come through their runs but there is a nice race for Excite in a couple of weeks at Ellerslie [Listed Champagne Stakes] and I think we could go there.

"If he could string two wins together, we might even look at something offshore as he has improved all season and is coping with his racing very well.

"I think he is a Guineas horse in the making."

Rooke noted the horse had always been held in high regard but was only now beginning to learn his trade.

"He has just been a lot greener than first anticipated when he first started running," he said.

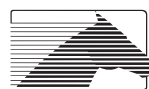
"He is learning all the time and today he did everything right. He is going to improve, be better over a mile and better again next year.

"He relaxed perfectly today and is very exciting. I think he could be a Group 1 horse."

Raced by his breeder Colin Litt and his wife Helen, who also had their multiple Group 1 winning mare Orchestral (Savabeel) in the stable, Excite is out of the stakes winning Savabeel (Zabeel) mare Elate, who herself is a half-sister to Bendigo Cup (Gr 3, 2400m) winner High Emoceen (Ocean Park).

The win provided Coolmore's late shuttle sensation Wootton Bassett with his 79th individual stakes winner.

## Morning Briefing

### Australia

#### Five for Home Affairs

Marffiano (Home Affairs), a half-brother to Tycoon Star (Written Tycoon), continued Lindsay Park's recent dominance of Bendigo's premier juvenile race with victory in the VOBIS Gold Rush (1100m). Prepared by Ben Hayes, Will Hayes and JD Hayes, the son of Home Affairs (I Am Invincible) led home a stable quinella, defeating Resonant (Spirit of Boom) by half-a-length, with Running Rich (Rich Enuff) a further 1.3 lengths away in third. The victory marked a third consecutive success in the race for the Lindsay Park operation, following wins with Killiana (Brazen Beau) and Bold Bastille (Brazen Beau), and also provided Coolmore's first-season sire Home Affairs with his fifth individual winner. Marffiano impressed on debut under Declan Bates, settling just off the speed before striking the front inside the final 150 metres. "He made my life pretty easy," Bates said. "He did everything right and felt better the further he went." Ben Hayes admitted the colt had been inconsistent in his work at home but showed his ability on raceday. "He's a laid-back customer and can be a bit lazy in trackwork, but to win a race like this first-up is a big thrill," Hayes said. The Hayes brothers and Laurel Oak Bloodstock paid \$475,000 for the colt at the 2025 Magic

Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale from Lime Country Thoroughbreds. Marffiano's dam, Miss Iano (Equiano) is proving a shrewd purchase by Yulong with her first foal, Tycoon Star winning the Tobin Bronze Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) last week. Miss Iano's third foal, a Written Tycoon (Iglesia) colt realised \$1.3 million at this year's Inglis Easter sale to the bid of Ciaran Maher and David Redvers. Home Affairs will stand the 2026 breeding season at Coolmore Australia for a fee of \$176,000 (inc GST).

#### Two for Sweynesse

Novara Park stallion Sweynesse (Lonhro) chalked up his second individual elite-level winner and tenth individual stakes winner on Saturday when the Phillip Stokes-trained Wigmore (3 g ex Del Mondo by More Than Ready) landed the South Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2500m) at Morphettville. Purchased by Kevin Myers for \$25,000 out of Ralph Thoroughbreds during Book 2 of the 2024 NZB Karaka Yearling Sale, Wigmore is raced by Terry Henderson's OTI Racing. He is out of the winning More Than Ready (Southern Halo) mare Del Mondo, making him a half-brother to New Zealand Cup (Gr 3, 3200m) winner Mondorani (Burgundy). Sweynesse stood the 2025 breeding season at a fee of NZ\$7,000 (plus GST).

#### Five for Grunt

Yulong stallion Grunt (O'Reilly) sired his fifth individual stakes winner on Saturday when Tiptop Tori (3 f ex Star Stopper by Hallowed Crown) proved too good for her 13 rivals in the Adelaide Guineas (Listed, 1600m) at Morphettville. Ridden by Jason Holder for trainer Andrew Gluyas, the filly denied Amedei by 1.2 lengths with a further 2.6 lengths back to the third-placed Yellowjacket (I Am Invincible). The win also provided Grunt with the middle leg of a winning treble on Saturday's Morphettville card. Out of the unraced Hallowed Crown (Street Sense) mare Star Stopper, Tiptop Tori is a half-sister to winners Moonfleet (Bolt D'Oro) and Peaky Blinder (Magna Grecia). Grunt will stand the 2026 breeding season at Yulong's Victorian base at a fee of \$16,500 (inc GST).

## 22 for Sir Prancealot

Alaingé (5 m ex Tipperary Lil by Blevic) became the 22nd individual stakes winner for Sir Prancealot (Tamayuz) when landing Saturday's Port Adelaide Cup (Listed, 2518m) at Morphettville. Ridden by Harry Grace for trainer Garret Lynch, the five-year-old mare ran out a dominant 2.7 lengths winner over Sir Kingsford in a one-two for the stallion. There was a further 0.2 lengths back to Sea What I See (Sea The Stars) in third. Out of the winning Blevic (Scenic) mare Tipperary Lil, Alaingé is a sister to winner Torrita. Sir Prancealot is standing the 2026 northern hemisphere breeding season at Rancho San Miguel for a fee of US\$6,000 (approx. AU\$8,330).

## 34 for Churchill

Churchill's Choice (4 m ex She's Choice by Churchill) delivered on her long-promised ability with a powerful late surge to claim the Hawkesbury Gold Cup (Gr 3, 1600m), providing Coolmore's former shuttler Churchill (Galileo) with his 34th individual stakes winner. Ridden by Regan Bayliss for trainer Nathan Doyle, the mare swept down the outside to score by a half-length over Palmetto (Ghibellines), with War Eternal (Pierro) the same distance further back in third. "She's always had the ability but hadn't won one of these stakes races," Doyle said. "To see her do it now is very satisfying, and I'm especially pleased for her owner Kevin Hill." The victory capped a tactical shift from the stable, with Doyle opting to refine her

racings pattern following a pair of inconsistent runs earlier in her preparation. "She can hit a flat spot between the 500 metres and the 300 metres," he said. "That's where she's been losing her races, so the key was keeping her in the race at that point." Bayliss, who partnered the mare in a key lead-up trial, executed the plan to perfection. "I wanted to have her within striking distance and keep her momentum going," he said. "Once she balanced up, she showed a really strong turn of foot." The win, at just her third start this preparation, secures Churchill's Choice a ballot exemption into the \$3 million Big Dance (1600m) at Randwick on Melbourne Cup Day. However, Doyle indicated more immediate targets are likely, with the Scone Cup (Listed, 1600m) under consideration as her next assignment. Out of the winning Choisir (Danhill Dancer) mare She's Choice, Churchill's Choice is a half-sister to four winners. Churchill, who shuttled to Coolmore Australia between 2018-2024, is standing at Coolmore Stud in Ireland for a fee of €15,000 (approx. AU\$24,420).

## 17 for Better Than Ready

Chidiac (5 m ex Bewitchment by Encosta De Lago) continued her upward trajectory with a determined victory in the Hawkesbury Crown (Gr 3, 1300m), providing Lyndhurst Stud stallion Better Than Ready (More Than Ready) with his 17th individual stakes winner. The Country Championships Final (1400m) winner made a successful step into stakes company, prevailing by 0.1 lengths over Surfin' Bird (The Autumn Sun), with Arriving Home (I Am Invincible) sticking on gamely for a 0.8 lengths third after setting the pace. Trained by Brett Cavanaugh in partnership with daughter Georgie, the mare has now won seven of her 12 starts, with Saturday's success marking the most significant victory of her career to date. "This was stepping over the line for me," Cavanaugh said. "I like to keep them graded, but with mares you have to chase black type, and now

she's got that on her page she's very valuable." Ridden by Braith Nock, the win also carried added significance, with the leading apprentice bringing up his 300th career victory. "I had that in mind, I wanted to give him his 300th winner," Cavanaugh said. "It's a great result for him, the stable and everyone involved." Owned by Gerry Harvey, Chidiac has developed into one of the more progressive mares in work this season, combining consistency with a sharp turn of foot. Plans beyond Hawkesbury remain open, although the Dark Jewel Classic (Gr 3, 1400m) at Scone looms as a logical next step. "We'll see how she pulls up, but the Dark Jewel is an option. She gets 1400 metres, so there's a bit to think about," Cavanaugh said. Out of the unraced Encosta De Lago (Fairy King) mare Bewitchment, Chidiac is a half-sister to four winners. Better Than Ready stood the 2025 breeding season at a fee of \$27,500 (inc GST).

## 22 for Harry Angel

Darley shuttler Harry Angel (Dark Angel) chalked up his 22nd individual stakes winner on Saturday when the Peter Snowden-trained Zealously (4 g ex Duenna by Sepoy) took out the Hawkesbury Gold Rush (Listed, 1100m) at Hawkesbury. Ridden by Tom Sherry, the four-year-old gelding ran out a 1.7 lengths winner over Bev's Nine (Shalaa) with a further 0.6 lengths back to the third-placed Monte Supreme (I Am Invincible). "I was a little bit worried when I saw the track today. You wouldn't want it any wetter for him," Snowden said. "But I thought he'd be able to control the speed and when he got a soft sectional between the 400 and the corner, he was going to be hard to beat. I think we will look at Brisbane with him now. I've got Fire Star and King Of Sparta for Scone, so I'm just trying to spread them around." Purchased by Snowden Racing and Will Johnson Bloodstock for \$270,000 out of Widden Stud at the 2023 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale, Zealously is the only winning foal from two to race out of the winning

### Skyhook stakes Stradbroke claim with Hawkesbury Guineas win

Skyhook (3 c Written Tycoon - Madame Pauline by Redoute's Choice) underlined his class with a dominant front-running victory in the Hawkesbury Guineas (Gr 3, 1400m), earning consideration for a tilt at the Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1400m). Trained by Gerald Ryan and Sterling Alexiou, the colt was expertly handled by Josh Parr, who executed pre-race instructions to perfection by taking up the lead and controlling the race. "We noticed there wasn't much early speed, so we decided to lead and take bad luck out of the equation," Ryan said. Skyhook (\$3.40) carried 58 kilograms to victory, defeating Burma Star (Exceed and Excel) by 1.5 lengths, with Wootton Lass (Wootton Bassett) a further half-length away in third. The performance has connections eyeing a Brisbane winter campaign, with the Stradbroke Handicap at Eagle Farm now firmly on the radar. "Skyhook is a well-bred colt so you have to look at Group 1 options," Ryan said. A potential pathway could include the Fred Best Classic (Gr 3, 1400m) as a lead-up, offering ballot exemption into the Stradbroke.

### Stormy Marco leads Waller trifecta in Clarendon upset

Stormy Marco (Wootton Bassett) made a winning debut as he led home a Chris Waller-trained trifecta in the Clarendon Stakes (1400m) at Hawkesbury. Stormy Marco settled off the speed under Sam Clipperton before finishing strongly to defeat stablemate Nations League (Snitzel) by 0.4 lengths, with Fondness (Frankel) a further 2.1 lengths away in third. Sent out at odds of \$21, Stormy Marco was the least-fancied of Waller's trio, but delivered

an impressive performance in the traditional Hawkesbury two-year-old feature. Stable representative Charlie Duckworth indicated both Stormy Marco and Nations League are likely to head towards the J J Atkins (Gr 1, 1600m) at Eagle Farm. "Stormy Marco had trialled well and had the education to go to the races," Duckworth said. "The 1400 metres suited and he was strong late." Clipperton was also taken by the colt's performance. "He's a quiet-natured horse and will only improve off that," he said. In contrast, \$1.22 favourite Tenenbaum (Snitzel) had every chance but faded late to finish fourth. Stormy Marco is a graduate of the 2024 Inglis Australian Weanling Sale, when he was purchased by Tasman Bloodstock from the Rathmore Lodge draft for \$70,000. The colt was re-offered at the 2025 Inglis Easter Yearling Sale, where Chris Waller paid \$300,000 for him, from the Coolmore Stud consignment.

### Golden Straand pushes for stakes shot after Hawkesbury win

Golden Straand (Snitzel) continued his upward trajectory with an impressive victory in the Blakes Marine Benchmark 78 Handicap (1100m) at Hawkesbury, strengthening his case for a rise to stakes company. Ridden by Nash Rawiller, the son of Snitzel (Redoute's Choice) settled back before cutting the corner and surging clear to defeat Wanaruah (Snitzel) by a half-length. Trainer Matthew Smith said the four-year-old had continued to impress with his authority and consistency. "He's building a very good record and winning his races well," Smith said. "He's run a fast time again and carried a big weight. We'll assess options, whether we keep working through the grades or look at a race like the Luskin Star Stakes." Golden Straand has now won five of his ten starts and four of six this campaign, emerging as a potential black-type contender. The entire, owned by Gerry Harvey, also set a track record over 1200 metres at

Warwick Farm last spring, further underlining his ability. Smith believes the best is still to come. "He did a few things wrong early, but he's settling better now and finding the line," he said. "There's still improvement there, he's got a future."

### 172 for Snitzel

The Next Episode (2 c ex Humma Humma by Denman) became the first of a new stakes double on Saturday for late Arrowfield Stud stalwart Snitzel (Redoute's Choice) when he scored in the Dalrello Stakes (Listed, 1000m) at Eagle Farm. Having previously finished a narrow second in the Kindergarten Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) last month, the Ciaron Maher-trained colt made amends here as he defeated Lucky Pat (Lucky Vega) by an impressive 2.9 lengths under Jason Collett. There was a further 1.2 lengths back to the third-placed Dream Roca (El Roca). "We always knew he was dynamic and he always shows plenty of ability at home. He's got his manners intact today and didn't make a mistake," stable representative Sam Cavanaugh said. "He's a very expensive colt, so full credit to the owners over in the UK and the bunch of very good supporters for the stable. He's an absolute dude." Humma Humma was bought for \$1 million by Widden Stud at the 2021 Magic Millions National Broodmare Sale and has produced four foals in a row before missing last spring after delivering a filly by Zoustar (Northern Meteor). Widden sold a yearling I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit) colt from Humma Humma at Inglis Easter this year for \$600,000 to McEvoy Mitchell Racing and Belmont Bloodstock.

Having landed the Daybreak Lover (Listed, 1400m) on his start previous, the Chris and Corey Munce-trained Brave Monarch (3 g Brave Smash - Puppet Queen by Kingmambo) made it back-to-back stakes victories when landing Saturday's Queensland Guineas (Gr 2, 1600m) at Eagle Farm. Ridden by Martin Harley, the three-year-old gelding defeated Tupakara (Trapeze Artist) by 1.1 lengths with a further 1.6 lengths back to Call Da Vinci (Under The Louvre) in third. Chris Munce revealed post-race that the yard will aim to get Brave Monarch into the Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1400m) back at Eagle Farm next month. "I tell you what about the 1000-metre mark I was thinking this isn't looking real good. He got buffeted basically from the 1400-metre mark to the 400 metres, but he held his nerve and he held his ground. It's a testament to both horse and rider," Chris Munce said. "Martin [Harley] is always very confident and when he says something you back his judgment. He said he's going to be three pairs back and cut the corner and get out in the straight, but then he went about six or seven pairs back! He'll [Brave Monarch] have to go around in the Fred Best [Classic] and run well to get in the Stradbroke, but that is a possibility."

### Splash Back proves too strong in Victory Stakes

Splash Back (6 m Le Havre - Tamazirte by Danehill Dancer) will be headed for next month's Tattersall's Tiara (Gr 1, 1400m) following her success in Saturday's Victory Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) at Eagle Farm. Ridden by Michael Rodd, the Grahame Begg-trained mare produced a good performance as she defeated Payline (Shooting To Win) by 1.7 lengths to register her second Group 2 success. There was a further 0.1 lengths back to Warnie (Highland Reel) in third. "They went along at a decent

clip, and I was out the back and wasn't going anywhere straightening up," Rodd said. "I was struggling a bit and thought, I'm staying on the inside. I couldn't believe it was opening up in front of my eyes, and she will be even better when she gets out over a little bit further." Stable representative Jack Lake praised the ride and revealed the mare is on target for her Group 1 task. "Just to get up on the rail and save ground was crucial," Lake said. "She is spot-on for the Tatt's Tiara. She has beaten some good horses today and we always thought she was up to that class."

Purchased by her owner John Wheeler for \$375,000 out of Coolmore Stud at the 2024 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale, Gold Coast Belle is a half-sister to winners Syzygy Stars (Vancouver) and Allasandra (Pride Of Dubai) being out of the unraced More Than Ready mare Perpetuum.

### Von Hauke gains redemption in Bendigo's Golden Mile

The Cliff Brown-trained Von Hauke (6 g Savabeel - Tiara by O'Reilly) added his third stakes victory on Saturday when landing the Golden Mile (Listed, 1600m) at Bendigo. Earlier on the card, stablemate Insatiable (Farnan) made it back-to-back wins in the Bush Inn Open Sprint (1200m), continuing a productive run for the stable.

### Stonybreck returns to winning ways in Riccarton thriller

Stonybreck (Tavistock) bounced back to form with a determined victory in the Easter Cup (1600m) at Riccarton on Saturday, prevailing in a blanket finish for trainers Mark Walker and Sam Bergerson. ### Bow Echo imperious in 2,000 Guineas as Loughnane gets first Classic

Having signed off a perfect two-year-old campaign with a win in the Royal Lodge Stakes (Gr 2, 1m), the George Boughey-trained Bow Echo extended his unbeaten record to four when he reigned supreme in Saturday's English 2,000 Guineas.

Ridden by Billy Loughnane, the colt travelled well to the two-furlong pole and, when let down by his rider, found plenty under pressure to beat the Aidan O'Brien-trained Gstaad (Starspangledbanner) by two and three-quarter lengths in what looked a classy renewal of the British Classic.

There was a further eight lengths back to the third-placed Distant Storm (Night Of Thunder) as the front pair pulled well clear of the other 12 runners.

Loughnane, who was enjoying his first Classic win at just 20 years of age, told ITV: "I've wanted to be a jockey since the day I was born. Competing in these races is what we want.

"To find a horse like this at 20 years old is a dream come true and I can't thank everyone enough. I can't put it into words, I've never had a feeling like that before.

"I didn't, but he's a horse who is so asleep. He jumped out and found a perfect

rhythm. There was more pace in the race than he's ever faced, he's a superstar."

Meanwhile, Boughey cut an emotional figure post-race and also paid tribute to Bow Echo's late owner-breeder Sheikh Mohammed Obaid Al Maktoum.

"He [Bow Echo] was good, wasn't he?, Boughey said. "I thought he might do that, his work's been incredibly good, so lucky he was as good as we thought he was.

"He had an amazing brain, Sheikh Mohammed Obaid, and he knew he'd be better as a three-year-old. He insisted he didn't run in the Dewhurst, I thought he'd have won the Dewhurst, and he'd have been the 6-4 favourite if he'd won. To find a horse like this is amazing.

"I thought Billy gave him a wonderful ride. He waited as long as I wanted. I think I'm trying not to cry, to be honest, to win both Guineas as a Newmarket trainer is pretty cool."

However, Boughey did throw cold water on a potential crack at the Epsom Derby (Gr 1, 1m 4f) with the colt, saying: "I don't think so [on going to the Derby]. He wasn't entered in the Derby, he's a very fast horse. His work suggests he could win a Group 1 over six. But he relaxes. He could get further because he's a good horse, but he's from a mile-ing family and at the moment that's where we'll be looking."

A Runner was purchased for US\$1.05 million by Douglas Scharbauer at the 2024 Keeneland September Yearling Sale and he races the filly in partnership with her breeder. Always A Runner is out of the Grade 2-placed Malibu Moon (A.P. Indy) mare Always Carina, herself a half-sister to 2019 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf (Gr 1, 8f) winner Structor (Palace Malice). Gun Runner is standing at a fee of US\$250,000 (approx. AU\$347,130).
