Desert Lightning strikes in thrilling Goodwood finish

Former New Zealand gelding Desert Lightning (Pride Of Dubai) showed his remarkable versatility once again in storming to a thrilling triumph in Saturday's The Goodwood (Gr 1, 1200m) at Morphettville.

Bringing another elite title to the old firm of Peter Moody and Luke Nolen – at the place where they so memorably lifted the race with Black Caviar (Bel Esprit) 14 years ago – Desert Lightning scored in a frenetic finish to bring a second feature in quick succession for Pride Of Dubai (Street Cry).

Twenty-two minutes earlier, the Coolmore stallion's star performer Pride Of Jenni had won the Gold Coast's Hollindale Stakes (Gr 2, 1800m).

Jumping from barrier four of 14 with the maximum 56 kilograms in the set weights Goodwood, Desert Lightning settled eighth, one off the fence, behind a strong tempo.

Yulong's \$6.50 third-favourite Tycoon Star (Written Tycoon) had travelled strongly outside the longshot leader Power Beau (Brazen Beau) on a Morphettville Soft 6, and duly charged to the front at the 200 metres. But while some were hailing him as the winner, so much was still to happen.

Continued from page 1 Grand Larceny (Zoustar) stormed up on Tycoon Star's right, and New York Lustre (Manhattan Rain) (\$20) staked a bold claim for the lead on his left.

Wider out Desert Lightning was winding up with a powerhouse finish, but he too soon looked under threat as \$3.50 favourite Extragalactic (Deep Field) emerged from behind him, the three-year-old filly unleashing a withering run under apprentice Luke Cartwright and just 50 kilos.

The five horses charged to the finish, with the outside pair eventually barrelling to the lead, and while many would have felt Extragalactic had done enough, the photo revealed the bobbing heads ended with Desert Lightning getting his nose down at the line, scoring by 0.02 lengths.

"I wasn't sure," Nolen said. "But that (TV) drone kept following me around everywhere. I thought, 'Oh, it must be a bloody chance!'"

"We had a really economical run in the race. He had a winnable weight, I presented him to win the race and I wasn't sure at the line."

Grand Larceny held on for third at \$17, ahead of New York Lustre and Tycoon Star.

Desert Lightning was easy in betting, starting at \$18. That was perhaps in keeping with the six-year-old's race history as he took on a field of gun sprinters.

The gelding's first stakes win came in the 2023 Avondale Guineas (Gr 2, 2100m). His first of what's now a pair of elite victories came over the mile in Trentham's TAB Classic (Gr 1, 1600m), a distance at which he was also placed twice at the top level in New Zealand.

And last spring, he ran a solid fifth in the

Underwood Stakes (Gr 1, 1800m) after winning over 1500 metres at Moonee Valley.

Originally trained in New Zealand by Peter and Dawn Williams before joining Moody and co-trainer Katherine Coleman at Pakenham in 2024, Desert Lightning now has eight wins from 1100 to 2100 metres, and \$2.2 million in earnings.

"He participated in an All Star Mile before he came to us, so we weren't sure," Nolen said of Desert Lightning's ninth in that event in 2024, behind the aforementioned Pride Of Jenni.

"We thought that [1600 metres] was probably his niche. But he had a little bit of help with some surgery off season, and since then he's been doing it first rate at home, so it was good to see him turn that confidence we've had in his work into winning a Group 1 here in Oz.

"He's been flying at home. He had a tough run with 60 kilos on his back first up in the Hareeba Stakes," said Nolen, who rode him to fourth in that 1200-metre sprint at Mornington on April 18.

"The camp and myself had genuine hopes that he could win the race here today."

A delighted Coleman - marking her seventh Group 1 with Moody after her partner's 57 while solo - said stable favourite Desert Lightning had again shown he could more than hold his own in an elite sprint, particularly early in a campaign.

"We thought he was going to be a horse that would stretch out over ground as well, but he just seems he's best when he's fresh and happy and bouncing, and that's how he was today," she said.

"He's such a tough horse. He's such a character. He's a genuine stable favourite. We just all adore him and his owners, Chris and Sarah Green. They've travelled from New

Zealand to Adelaide today to be here for this. He's a part of their family and it's just so special.

"He's so quirky, he's got so much character. He's an older gelding. Normally, they're the quiet ones that know their job and they don't cause too much fuss. Well, he carries on out there like a two-year-old colt most mornings, and upsets other horses on the track and bounces around the stable."

Nolen forecast Desert Lightning could now be in line for a return to Moody's original home state for a second tilt at the Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1400m), in which he made good ground to run fourth last year.

"The horse has been going really well, so I think the next port of call is Queensland for another go at the Stradbroke," said Nolen, celebrating his 42nd Group 1.

Bookmakers wound Desert Lightning into \$11 equal favouritism for Queensland's feature race on Saturday night.

Bought by Peter and Dawn Williams from Little Avondale Stud's draft at Karaka 2021 for NZ\$150,000, Desert Lightning is the fourth foal of unraced Australian mare Isstoora (High Chaparral).

The mare's fifth foal is also a stakes winner in Oak Hill (Per Incanto), who's won at Group 2 level for Team Hayes. Eighth foal Oak Lightning (Per Incanto) is also in the Moody-Coleman camp, and the two-year-old gelding earned a stakes placing in his only start to date when a 0.3-length second in Caulfield's Redoute's Choice Stakes (Listed, 1200m) on April 11.

Continuing a successful mating, Isstoora now has a weanling filly by Per Incanto (Street Cry) and was covered for a sixth time by the Little Avondale stallion last spring.

Hailing from the ultra successful female line of American blue hen Best In Show (Traffic Judge), Desert Lightning shares the same third dam - Twyla (Danehill) - with another autumn elite victor in Queen Of The Turf Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Idle Flyer (Dundeel).

Desert Lightning is one of five Group 1 winners for Pride Of Dubai and is among the 13-year-old's 24 stakes victors from 557 runners, at 4.3 per cent.

Pride Of Dubai, who finished a surprising third on the Australian general sires' table last season, will stand at an unchanged \$22,000 (inc GST) at Coolmore this spring.

Naifah enhances pedigree with Proud Miss success

Three-year-old filly Naifah (I Am Invincible) became her super sire's 125th stakes winner and joined three-quarter sister and stablemate Charm Stone (I Am Invincible) as a black type victor in taking Morphetville's Proud Miss Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) on Saturday.

Sold as a late two-year-old with three starts

and a Listed-placing to her name at the 2025 Gold Coast National Broodmare Sale, the regally-bred Naifah has been a work in progress for the Mick Price and Michael Kent Jnr stable, who took her over from Team McEvoy following that auction.

She won a Hawkesbury Super Maiden on stable debut last October, but managed only two minor placings in five subsequent runs that preparation, though at least one was in black type when third in Geelong's Black Pearl (Listed, 1200m).

But after resuming with an eye-catching third in a 1200-metre three-year-old fillies' metro handicap at Mornington on April 18, Naifah was on-form against older mares on Saturday in scoring her first stakes success.

Starting an easy \$4.20 favourite, Naifah bounded to a comfortable lead from gate two of 12 and was well rated in front by Zac Lloyd, given a relatively easy time by his rivals. Under the set-weights minimum of 54 kilograms, the filly was still full of running in the home straight and came away untroubled to win by 2.7 lengths.

Two \$31 bolters filled the minors, with Peter and Belinda Blanch's five-year-old mare Lingani (America) second, earning a third black type placing alongside one Listed success, and Jason Warren's four-year-old Flyer (Exceedance) also notching a third stakes placing besides one Group 3 win.

Five-year-old Aviatress (Smart Missile) was fourth as \$3 favourite.

Naifah was put through the Gold Coast broodmare sale by her breeders Emirates Park. She was bought for \$400,000 by Steve Grant's Silverdale Farm and Andy Williams Bloodstock, with prominent owner and breeder Neil Werrett among five others taking a share.

"She did a great job today and Zac rode her really well, got her in front," Werrett said post-race.

"So that was a great result for her and her page. Stevie Grant bought her, and I took a little bit of her and I was pretty happy.

"She controlled that the whole way. I mean, her form was a lot better than the other horses today. And Price and Junior have done a great job to bring her over here and place her, and the whole aim was to get black type and to win this race. So she's worth a fair bit now."

Lloyd said he anticipated leading according to the speed map, and felt Naifah was primed for success even before the race. **Cont. on page 5**

“I must say, cantering to the gates, I thought that you're going to need a good one to beat her,” he said. “She just felt enormous, a very well constituted filly, so I think she can go on to better things. She is still quite raw as well.

“Mick rang me this morning. He's very straightforward, knows his horses inside out. He doesn't keep you too long, tells you what he needs and lets you bounce.

“I think anyone could have won on her today. She was pretty straightforward.”

Naifah is the first foal of the Emirates Park-bred Najmah (Snitzel), a city winner of two races and a half-sister to Charm Stone – a dual Group 1-winning sprinter along with three other stakes races – and to her dual Listed-winning sister Najmaty.

The three mares' dam Najoom (Northern Meteor) won two Group 3s among five race victories.

Najmah now has a yearling filly by Harry Angel (Dark Angel), a weanling filly by Tassort (Brazen Beau), and was covered by Ole Kirk (Written Tycoon) last spring.

Triple champion sire I Am Invincible, standing at Yarraman Park this year at an unchanged \$220,000 (inc GST), has 125 stakes winners from 1,353 runners at a resounding 9.24 per cent.

On-song Jenni insuperable in Hollindale Stakes

There's precious little even the best rivals in Australia can do when the eight-year-old Pride Of Jenni (Pride Of Dubai) is in the right mood, and jockey Declan Bates knew she was in that mindset a long way from home at the Gold Coast on Saturday.

The wonder mare did it again to another high class field in the Hollindale Stakes (Gr 2, 1800m), stealing an insurmountable mid-race break as rival jockeys as illustrious as James McDonald and Jamie Melham were left with few cards to play.

Jumping from gate three of ten, Pride Of Jenni steamed to a five-length lead after 300 metres. By the halfway point, the \$3.30 favourite was 12 lengths clear of the peloton, which already seemed in a race for second.

Turning for home at the 350-metre mark,

Jenni was still ten lengths clear.

As McDonald threw everything at \$4.20 third-favourite Birdman (Free Eagle), who'd traveled just behind midfield, and Melham sent \$3.80 second-elect Half Yours (St Jean) to the outside for his run, it was clear the super mare would have to suddenly hit a wall to not win again.

She did not. Birdman made a stoic effort, but it was too little in view of the task at hand.

Pride Of Jenni held on comfortably, by 0.8 lengths. Grahame Begg's She's A Hustler (Ace High) took third, 2.2 lengths further back at \$4.60, while Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) hero Half Yours finished fairly to complete the shortest possible first four.

It was a ninth stakes victory for Tony Ottobre's remarkable mare, alongside an All-Star Mile (1600m) success before that race was black type. She now has 13 wins from 47 stars for \$12.34 million in earnings.

Though this first visit to the Gold Coast wasn't quite as spectacular as her 6.54-length success in Randwick's Queen Elizabeth Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) two years ago, and while she's soon to turn nine, there seems little reason to contemplate retirement just yet.

Bates, who's ridden the mare 23 times for eight wins and seven minors, said he could tell soon after mounting up that Pride Of Jenni was in the mood for battle.

“I really just work with her,” the expat Irishman said. “It's all about her terms, especially when she's really loving it and nice

and on song -- and I knew very early today. It was like, 'We're in business.'

“It's the first time since Queen Elizabeth when I knew I was happy, but at the same time I have just got to manage her. So it's a matter of letting her take me in.”

Trainer Ciaran Maher said he'd given Pride Of Jenni a relatively easy lead in to the Gold Coast – now the sixth track she's won at – given she'd had three searching runs this preparation.

All were at the elite level, including a first-up 0.6-length third in the All-Star Mile and her gallant 0.02-length second in the Australian Cup (Gr 1, 2000m) to stablemate Light Infantry Man (Fast Company).

“We were mindful that she has had three very tough runs, and given how well she went first-up, I just thought the only thing you can do is overtrain her,” the master trainer said.

“So she's been to the Bong Bong Farm and some pretty nice establishments and we just kept her fresh, and it was a great win. She slept well and I thought we might be on today. It was great for Tony. He's got friends and family up here so it was fantastic.”

Asked what would come next, he said: “We'll just have a look at her but she's just a beautiful mare and she is looking better and better.”

Bookmakers have Pride Of Jenni as a \$4.50 equal second favourite for the Doomben Cup (Gr 1, 2000m) on May 23, alongside Birdman and behind \$3.50 shot Half Yours.

Continued from page 5 Bred by Brent and Cherry Taylor of New Zealand's Trelawney Stud and the Taylor Family Trust, Pride Of Jenni is the first foal out of four-time winner Sancerre (O'Reilly), herself a daughter of Queensland Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) winner Vouvray (Zabeel).

She was bought for just \$100,000 by Ottobre's Cape Schanck Stud at Inglis Classic 2019.

Sancerre has had five other foals. Three of them are unraced, the latest is a yearling filly by Hello Youmzain (Kodiak), and the other is Awatere (Per Incanto), a metro winner in New Zealand.

Pride Of Dubai (Street Cry), standing at Coolmore this year for an unchanged \$22,000 (inc GST), has 24 stakes winners from 557 runners, at 4.3 per cent.

St Gotthard all class in Ken Russell romp

High-priced colt St Gotthard (Snitzel) showed he might be every bit as good as his big brother Switzerland with an imperious victory in Saturday's Ken Russell Memorial Classic (Gr 3, 1200m) for two-year-olds.

The second top lot at the 2025 Inglis Easter Yearling Sale - bought for \$2.7 million from Arrowfield's draft by Coolmore's Tom Magnier - St Gotthard went into the event off a 0.2-length win in a 1200-metre Warwick Farm maiden on debut, when a \$1.75 favourite.

The son of Snitzel (Redoute's Choice) also graduated to stakes class with big shoes to fill as the two-years-younger full-brother of Switzerland, himself a \$1.5 million purchase for Magnier, who won his first three starts. He later took the Coolmore Stud Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) alongside two Group 2s, and now stands at Coolmore for \$55,000 (inc GST).

Long before last year's Easter sale, Arrowfield's bloodstock manager Jon Freyer - the man responsible for buying the pair's Canadian dam Ms Bad Behavior (Blame) in the US - was enthusing that the future St Gotthard was a better type of yearling than even Switzerland.

And on the evidence seen at the Gold Coast on Saturday, he could well turn out to be a superior racehorse as well.

Trained like Switzerland by Chris Waller, and ridden again on Saturday by James McDonald, St Gotthard settled just behind midfield from gate two of eight, behind an only moderate pace.

The well supported \$2.40 favourite loomed ominously on straightening, four-wide and under a hold, and was going to win a

long way from home. He eventually burst past his rivals at the 200 metres and scored by four lengths, swishing his tail.

Paul Shailer's gelding Silken Salute (Hello Youmzain), winner of his past two at Eagle Farm, earned his first dash of black type in carrying the colours of his sire's home base Cambridge Stud into second place at \$8.50, while Tony Gollan's filly Boomeli (Spirit Of Boom) took third at \$5.50.

The real boom is on St Gotthard, who was held up for a late entry to racing by Waller, and was elevated post-race to equal favouritism for Eagle Farm's juvenile double of the BRC Sires' Produce Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) on May 30 and the JJ Atkins (Gr 1, 1600m) on June 13.

"He's a real classic looking colt and you know from the moment that he came into Chris's stable he's really just progressed nicely," said Waller's stable representative Darren Beadman.

"He just takes it all in his stride, he's very professional and he's making a good fist of racetrack performances.

"It was just nice to see him have another dimension to his racing pattern because he was on speed [on debut] but ... he just settled back behind them and let loose.

"He could've easily lined up in some of the bigger races over the autumn carnival but Chris treats them all as individuals and looks way beyond the moment, and it's providing dividends with this horse."

McDonald lavished high praise on St Gotthard in tipping him to earn a place among

the many stable stars of Waller's team.

"Chris is building with some really good horses and this colt will be no exception," McDonald said.

"He cost a lot of money and he's got a beautiful temperament. He's got incredible acceleration and he's all class."

Freyer had to stretch to \$US600,000 at the Fasig Tipton sale of 2019 to buy Ms Bad Behavior, who won four races from 1300 to 1600 metres including a Kentucky Downs Grade 3 and a Santa Anita Listed. She's one of three black type victors from another stakes-winning mare, Cumulonimbus (Stormy Atlantic).

The investment has paid off in spades, with Ms Bad Behavior's four sold Australian offspring netting a combined \$6.75 million, including another full-brother bought at Easter this year for \$2 million when Magnier teamed up with James Harron and Tony Fung.

Aside from stakes winners Switzerland and St Gotthard, the brood includes another full-brother in Michal Freedman's three-year-old Decorum, a \$550,000 yearling who's won three times - twice in Sydney - among five starts.

Ms Bad Behavior has yet another full-brother weanling at present, but after Snitzel's death last June, she is now in-foal to The Autumn Sun (Redoute's Choice).

St Gotthard becomes the 174th stakes winner from 1733 runners (10.04 per cent) for the late Arrowfield titan Snitzel, who has a commanding lead on the Australian general sires' table as he posthumously heads towards a fifth champion sire title.

125 for I Am Invincible

Three-quarter sister to dual Group 1 winner Charm Stone, Naifah (3 f I Am Invincible - Najmah, by Snitzel) provided Yarraman Park stalwart I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit) with his 125th individual stakes winner as a sire when she broke through in Saturday's Proud Miss Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) at Morphettville. Bred by Emirates Park, Naifah was put through the Gold Coast National Broodmare Sale by her breeders and was bought for \$400,000 by Steve Grant's Silverdale Farm and Andy Williams Bloodstock, with prominent owner and breeder Neil Werrett among five others taking a share. She is the first foal of the Emirates Park-bred Najmah (Snitzel), a city winner of two races and a half-sister to Charm Stone (I Am Invincible) and to her dual Listed-winning sister Najmaty. The three mares' dam Najoom (Northern Meteor) won two Group 3s among five race victories. Najmah now has a yearling filly by Harry Angel (Dark Angel), a weanling filly by Tassort (Brazen Beau), and was covered by Ole Kirk (Written Tycoon) last spring. Triple champion sire I Am Invincible, standing at Yarraman this year at an unchanged \$220,000 (inc GST), has 125 stakes winners from 1,353 runners at a resounding 9.24 per cent.

Eight for Niagara

New Zealand-bred filly Fringes (3 f ex Miss Jaydeejay, by Golan) became the eighth stakes winner for Hau Ora Farm stallion Niagara (Encosta De Lago) when she lifted Saturday's SA Fillies' Classic (Gr 3, 2546m) at Morphettville. Bred and raced by Trish Dunell, the three-year-old began her career in New Zealand with Ilone Kelly, winning on debut at Otaki, before joining Michael Hickmott in South Australia in March. After a confidence-building win over 2200 metres at Balaklava last month, she stepped back into black-type company and delivered a determined performance under Ben Melham, recovering after being checked on straightening to drive between Certainly Quiet (Dundeel) and Panda's Spectrum (Fiorente) and score narrowly. Fringes has now won three of her seven starts and is out of the Golan (Spectrum) mare Miss Jaydeejay, a full-sister to Victoria Derby (Gr 1, 2500m) winner Kibbutz.

Third for Anders

Brave Hustler (2 g ex night Husstler, by Reliable Man) became the third individual stakes winner for Widden Stud stallion Anders (Not A Single Doubt) when landed Saturday's David Coles AM Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) at Morphettville. A mere \$5,000 purchase from the Magic Millions Adelaide Yearling Sale, Brave Hustler is the first foal out of the Reliable Man (Dalakhani) mare

Night Hussler, a half-sister to multiple Group winner Night's Watch (Redwood). His third dam is Captain Cook Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Penny Gem (Pentire). Anders, whose oldest progeny are three-year-olds, stands at Widden Stud in New South Wales, where he will stand the 2026 season for a fee of \$9,900 (inc GST).

Unbeaten Anders gelding lands David Coles

Brave Hustler (Anders) continued the strong start made by Widden Stud's young sire Anders and maintained his unbeaten record with a strong victory in Saturday's David Coles AM Stakes at Morphettville. Arran Bay continues fine run of form

Arran Bay (7 g All Too Hard - Stolen Girlfriend, by Canny Lad) claimed his third black-type victory from his past four starts when taking Saturday's Cummings Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m) at Morphettville for trainer Phillip Stokes. Derby winner lands Gosford Gold Cup

Chris Waller-trained Asterix (7 g Tavistock - Mourasana, by Shirocco) continued his form revival with a record weight-carrying performance to win Saturday's Gosford Gold Cup (Listed, 2100m), becoming the highest-weighted winner of the race since metric measurements were introduced in 1972. Carrying 61 kilos, the gelding was given a patient ride by Jason Collett before bursting through the field to score by a length from Zaphod (Zarak), with Touristic (Frankel) another length away in third. The New Zealand Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) winner of 2022, Asterix had managed only one win in the following three years before turning his form around with success in The Beauford (Listed, 2300m) at Newcastle last November. He has since added the JRA Plate (Gr 3, 2000m) first-up and now the Gosford Gold Cup to suggest he is back near his best. Collett, who has partnered Asterix in each of his past three wins, said the gelding had again done the job when the right runs came. "He's flying," Collett said. "I was fortunate the tempo was great early. He got into a nice rhythm down the side and we worked together from there. I got a lot of lucky breaks but I had the horse to do it." Stable representative Zane Jones said the gelding was now likely to press on to Brisbane after posting back-to-back wins.

Athanatos lands lucrative win in The Coast

Phillip Stokes' decision to target Saturday's The Coast (1600m) with Athanatos (4 g I Am Immortal - Mumbeilly, by O'Reilly) paid immediate dividends when the gelding proved too strong in the \$500,000 Gosford feature.

Ridden for the first time by Kerrin McEvoy, the four-year-old settled close to the speed from a midfield draw before quickening strongly in the straight to defeat Sarrismo (I Am Invincible) by 1.1 lengths, with Grand Omaha (Omaha Beach) another 0.3 lengths away in third. McEvoy said Athanatos' spring form, particularly his fourth placing in the Toorak Handicap (Gr 1, 1600m), gave him confidence he would measure up. "I was pretty confident when I got the booking and looked at his runs," McEvoy said. "I gave 'Stokesy' a call yesterday and he backed it up. He said, 'he's in good form'. I got confidence from the fact the last time he went to the mile was in the Toorak, and as we know it's a competitive Group 1 handicap and he wasn't beaten far." Speaking from Morphetville, where he was overseeing runners on Goodwood day, Stokes said the race had been identified as an ideal test toward a possible Sydney spring campaign. "Next prep we're going to aim up for that," Stokes said in reference to the Five Diamonds (1800m). "This was a big prize money race, and the owners will be wrapped. I'm getting a handle on Sydney. It's something we want to explore more, so it's important to identify horses to send up. He might be a horse we now have to look at Brisbane with."

King Of Roseau makes it three straight

Peter Snowden believes King Of Roseau (4 g Capitalist - Dominica, by Choisir) is racing with a greater will to win than ever after the sprinter dug deep to claim Saturday's Takeover Target Stakes (Listed, 1200m) at Gosford. Ridden by Kerrin McEvoy, the chestnut edged out Harry's Yacht (Harry Angel) after a prolonged straight duel, with early leader Way To The Stars (Reward For Effort) a half-length away in third. Godolphin's Kerguelen (Lonhro), the \$3.90 favourite, never threatened and beat only one runner home. Snowden said King Of Roseau's competitiveness had carried him to another valuable win as he continued his

excellent season. "I could see the horse on his inside making his run with King Of Roseau but I just felt he would find a way," Snowden said. "King Of Roseau is in a frame of mind where he just wants to win. He has always been a good sprinter but he's gone to the next level this season. He's won six of his last nine starts and he just keeps getting better." Snowden said the gelding would now head toward the Kingsford-Smith Cup (Gr 1, 1300m) at Eagle Farm on May 30 and the Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1400m) on June 13. "I deliberately missed the Sydney autumn with King Of Roseau as he had a fair bit of travelling earlier in the season then went deep into summer winning at the Gold Coast and then back at Randwick," he said. "So, I freshened him and decided to concentrate on the Brisbane carnival. He will go to the Kingsford-Smith Cup next and 1300 metres is probably his best distance, then onto the Stradbroke Handicap."

I Am Dirty impresses in Gosford juvenile opener

I Am Dirty (2 f I Am Invincible - Dirty Thoughts, by So You Think) made a strong statement at Gosford on Saturday, opening her account with a dominant win in the 2YO Handicap (1200m) and earning praise from trainer Bjorn Baker as another filly with the potential to progress through the grades. Having her second start after an unplaced debut behind Bangkok Hottie (Too Darn Hot) at Randwick last month, the \$600,000 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale purchase was heavily backed into \$2.60

174 for Snitzel

St Gotthard (2 c ex Ms Bad Behavior, by Blame) became the 174th individual stakes winner for late Arrowfield titan Snitzel (Redoute’s Choice) when producing an impressive performance to land Saturday’s Ken Russell Memorial Classic (Gr 3, 1200m) at the Gold Coast. Bred by Arrowfield out of Grade 3-winning Canadian mare Ms Bad Behavior (Blame), St Gotthard is a full-brother to Coolmore Stud Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Switzerland and metro winner Decorum. Ms Bad Behavior – one of three black type victors from stakes-winning mare Cumulonimble (Stormy Atlantic) – was a \$US600,000 purchase for Arrowfield’s bloodstock manager Jon Freyer at the Fasig Tipton sale of 2019, and St Gotthard brought \$2.7 million when selling to Coolmore’s Tom Magnier at the 2025 Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale. Ms Bad Behavior’s four sold Australian offspring have netted a combined \$6.75 million, including another full-brother bought at Easter this year for \$2 million by Magnier, James Harron and Tony Fung. The daughter of Blame (Arch) has another Snitzel weanling at present and is now in-foal to The Autumn Sun (Redoute’s Choice). Snitzel

maintains a commanding lead on the Australian general sires’ table as he posthumously heads towards a fifth champion sire title.

16 for Redwood

Nightline (3 f ex Decimal, by El Roca) became the 16th black-type winner for Westbury Stud sire Redwood (High Chaparral) when taking Saturday’s Gold Coast Bracelet (Listed, 1800m). Prepared by Tony and Maddysen Sears, Nightline has rapidly developed through the grades this season. The New Zealand-bred filly settled near the tail of the field under Mark Du Plessis before charging through a narrow gap in the straight to defeat Single Red (Vanbrugh) by a length, with Fireball Miss (Bivouac) a further 1.3 lengths away in third. Purchased for NZ\$75,000 from Book 2 of the 2024 NZB National Yearling Sale at Karaka, Nightline has now won four of her eight starts and taken earnings beyond A\$290,000. Maddysen Sears said the stable had always held the filly in high regard and believed the return to a firmer surface and extra distance were key factors in her breakthrough stakes success. “She is very, very good, and I just knew she had the turn of foot to win,” Sears said. “Mark rode her perfectly, he didn’t panic. The turn of foot wasn’t there in Brisbane the other day in the wet, and I think that’s what cost her.” Tony Sears said respected horseman Lee Freedman had been confident for weeks that the filly could develop into a Queensland Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) contender. “This horse is very, very special,” Sears said. “You know she’s got gears that probably a lot of horses haven’t got.”

Beadman delivers in Gold Coast Guineas

Talented colt Beadman (3 c Snitzel - Iffranesia, by Iffraaj) put himself in the Stradbroke Handicap picture with a strong win in Saturday’s Gold Coast Guineas (Gr 3, 1200m), with more patient tactics helping the colt return to his best. After unplaced runs at his previous two starts in Sydney, Peter Snowden elected

to have Beadman ridden more conservatively and the change paid off, with James McDonald settling the colt before producing him late to defeat Nepo Baby (Lucky Vega) by a length, with Motorsports (Street Boss) a head away in third. Carrying 57.5 kilos, the son of Encryption (Lonhro) was ridden by Tom Sherry and proved too strong late, defeating Tuned (Zoustar) by 0.4 lengths, with Redford (Snitzel) another 0.4 lengths away in third. The win lifted Cifrado's earnings beyond \$1.8 million and added to a race record that already featured wins in the Sires' Produce Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m),

Spirit Of Boom Classic (Gr 2, 1200m), Vo Rogue Plate (Gr 3, 1350m) and Lough Neagh Stakes (Listed, 1350m). A \$320,000 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale purchase from Eureka Stud's draft, Cifrado is one of three winners from four runners out of the Excites (Danewin) mare Madame Fly, whose other progeny include Listed winner Miami Fleiss (Spirit Of Boom).

Prepared by Tony and Calvin McEvoy, the filly was heavily backed into \$2.10 favouritism and never gave supporters concern, leading throughout under Harry Coffey before drawing clear to defeat Jarbardar (Written By) by three lengths, with fellow Home Affairs juvenile Shooting Brake third. The \$1 million Magic Millions National 2YO Classic on the Gold Coast later this month is now firmly on the agenda for the filly, who races in the colours carried by champion mare Sunlight (Zoustar). "She's going to be looking to kick on up to Queensland," Calvin McEvoy said. "There's a \$1 million race up there to consider. She's very fast and the 1000 or 1100 metres, I don't think it matters, but I was so impressed with her attitude today." Natural Fling had been expected to debut prominently after impressive

jump-out performances at Flemington and Caulfield and became the ninth individual winner for booming young sire Home Affairs, whose service fee was recently increased to \$176,000 (inc GST) by Coolmore.

Blinkers do the trick with Plymouth

Lindsay Park co-trainer Ben Hayes credited the reapplication of blinkers for Plymouth's (The Autumn Sun) return to winning form in Saturday's Benchmark 100 Handicap (2000m) at Caulfield. Ridden by Jamie Mott, The Autumn Sun gelding settled prominently before scoring by 0.8 lengths over Howlin' Rain (Fiorente), with Brayden Star (Twilight Son) third. The victory was Plymouth's first since taking out the Benalla Cup (2100m) in September and followed a third placing at Flemington last start under Benchmark 100 conditions. "We just felt last start at Flemington that he probably hit the front early and peaked on his run," Hayes said. "The blinkers went on today and it was a ten-out-of-ten ride from Jamie." Hayes said the stable had been unsure how Plymouth would cope with the Soft 7 conditions, but the lightly raced four-year-old handled the ground comfortably. "I thought he did a good job handling that, so it's all very good going into winter," he said. The Lindsay Park team will now decide whether to send Plymouth north for the Queensland carnival or remain in Melbourne. "I was thinking about that, but I'll need to talk to my brothers," Hayes said. "But I know the owners don't mind a trip."

Bred by the Carter family, Pacifico becomes the first stakes winner to come from Montjeu (Sadler's Wells) mare Carib, who has produced six winners from eight to race as well as the unplaced mare Sade (Savabeel) - the dam of Group 3 winner Force Of Will (Power). Pacifico failed to meet his reserve at the 2022 NZB Ready to Run Sale when offered as part of KB Bloodstock's draft. Ardrossan, who sired two winners on the day with Daniel Miller-trained mare Loch Katrine also scoring at Arawa Park, will stand the 2026 breeding season at an unchanged fee of \$20,000 (plus GST).

Forsman completes northern feature double with Pacifico

Cambridge trainer Andrew Forsman enjoyed a feature-race double for the Carter family across New Zealand on Saturday, highlighted by Pacifico's determined victory in the Rotorua Cup. The son of Ardrossan relished a testing Heavy9 surface to claim his maiden stakes success after outlasting Savoir Faire (Savabeel) in a prolonged straight duel, with Proboy (Proisir) finishing third. Ridden by George Rooke, Pacifico settled in the trail after working forward early before launching his challenge turning for home alongside Savoir Faire. The pair quickly put a break on the field before Pacifico edged clear late to score by half a length. "He is a neat horse and just so honest," Forsman said. "I wasn't sure if he was going to run a strong 2200 metres on what is a very holding track, but it was a gutsy effort and a great ride from George. He keeps surprising, keeps stepping up and is getting better and better with age." Forsman also praised the support of owners Mark and John Carter, whose colours were carried earlier in the day by Waverley winner Mr Mojo Risin' (Deep Field). Rooke believed Pacifico benefited from a soft run in transit before proving too tough late. "It was a good battle down the straight with a few bumps here and there and I think he thrived on it," he said. Pacifico has now won seven of 26 starts and nearly \$250,000 in prize money.

Churchillian too strong in Rotorua Stakes

Cambridge mare Churchillian (6 m Churchill ex Fond du Coeur, by Fastnet Rock) produced a dominant front-running performance to claim her second stakes victory in Saturday's Rotorua ITM Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) at Arawa Park. The Tony Pike-trained six-year-old was one of several expected leaders in the fillies and mares feature, but rider Joe Doyle ensured she controlled proceedings after winning the early battle for the front from race favourite Kitty Flash (Ace High). Once allowed to dictate terms, Churchillian proved difficult to reel in and kicked strongly turning for home before scoring by two lengths over fast-finishing Platinum Diamond (Hello Youmzain), with stablemate Honey Badger (El Roca) third. "She's a marvellous horse and to see what she did today, she just put them away," Pike stable representative Chris McNab said. "Kitty Flash had to do a lot of work to get outside her, which we had banked on, and everything went picture perfect the whole way. She is a good, tough mare and that is her tenth win today. Not many horses do that." Doyle also reflected on the significance of the victory, which came almost exactly a year after he won the same race aboard Tomodachi (Tarzino) before flying to Sweden following a serious raceday fall involving partner Ulrika Holmquist. "It has been a tough year, but we are all doing well now," he said. Bred by Pencarrow Thoroughbreds, Churchillian is the first foal out of Fastnet Rock (Danehill) mare Fond du Coeur.

Jaeger breaks through at Waverley

Promising four-year-old Jaeger (Time Test) delivered on his potential with a dominant front-running victory in Saturday's Waverley Harvesting 1650 (1650m) at Waverley for trainer Robbie Patterson. Starlust to make racing return after one season at stud

Grade 1-winning sprinter Starlust (Zoustar) has returned to training in the UK after completing one season at Riverstone Lodge in the Hunter Valley.

The son of Zoustar (Northern Meteor), who covered 102 mares at a fee of \$27,500 (inc GST) in his debut season, has rejoined former trainer Ralph Beckett and is scheduled to resume in the Temple Stakes (Gr 2, 5f) at Haydock on May 23.

Explaining the decision, Alex Cole, racing

manager to Starlust's owners Jim and Fitri Hay, said that Starlust's fertility had impacted confidence around a second season at stud.

"He got about 70 mares in foal, but his fertility wasn't the greatest," Cole said. "We thought he might struggle for support in his second season, so we brought him back into training."

A Group winner in Britain, Starlust claimed the Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint (Gr 1, 5f) at Del Mar in 2024 and was last seen finishing fourth in the King Charles III Stakes

(Gr 1, 5f) at Royal Ascot.

Cole indicated a future return to stud remains possible.

"He's certainly not infertile and he's been left entire," he said. "A stallion career is not off the table and, if he gets a good one in his first crop in Australia, we can revisit the situation."

Should Starlust make it back to Royal Ascot, he could be joined by fellow Zoustar flag-bearer Joliestar, who trialled quietly at Warwick Farm on Friday ahead of her proposed UK campaign.

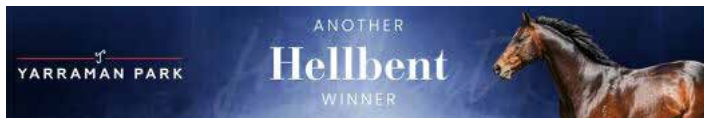

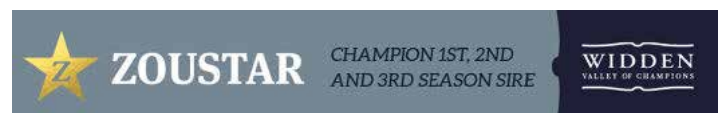
