Anders defies fee slide with growing stakes momentum

He covered 21 mares last year and has had his service fee lowered for the coming spring, but there are few second-season sires faring better than Anders (Not A Single Doubt) at present.

Widden Stud's low-priced eight-year-old welcomed his third stakes winner - all this season - on Saturday when two-year-old Brave Hustler took Morphetville's David Coles Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) by 1.5 lengths, remaining unbeaten after claiming a Murray Bridge two-year-old maiden on debut.

And while Anders has taken his time to bear fruit, he's been making up for it lately - hence Widden are reporting an uptick in early bookings for him this spring.

He's risen into the top ten on the second-season sires' table by earnings of late and moved up one spot to ninth thanks to Brave Hustler's Coles Stakes win.

But Anders sits equal second by stakes winners, as one of four sires with three of them, and shares second by stakes wins (four) with Darley's Bivouac (Exceed And Excel). Only that sire's Darley barnmate Ghaiyyath (Dubawi) sits ahead, with five stakes winners of eight black type races.

Home Affairs adds tenth winner as Home Tomurra scores at Sunshine Coast

Champion freshman sire elect Home Affairs (I Am Invincible) continued his remarkable season on Sunday when Home Tomurra became his tenth individual winner with victory at the Sunshine Coast. Fittingly, the colt was bred and sold by Torryburn Stud, the nursery which also bred Home Affairs before selling the future dual Group 1-winning sprinter to Tom Magnier for \$875,000 at the 2020 Inglis Australian Easter Yearling sale.

Continued from page 1 And on price, dual stakes-winning sprinter Anders is punching well above his weight.

Ghaiyyath is standing for \$88,000 (all fees inc GST) this spring, while the other three second-season sires with three stakes winners are Bivouac on \$33,000, the late Wootton Bassett (Iffraaj), who stood for \$385,000 last spring, and Ole Kirk (Written Tycoon), whose fee has risen to \$110,000 this year.

Anders will stand for \$9,900, down from \$13,200 in 2025.

And one rung below him, with two stakes winners this term, is Kia Ora's Farnan (Not A Single Doubt), with a fee of \$77,000.

While his two stakes successes came over 1100 metres at Rosehill in The Rosebud (Listed, 1100m) and San Domenico Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) - with his blistering speed shown in margins of 4.8 lengths and 3.3 lengths - and despite being by a speed sire in Not A Single Doubt (Redoute's Choice), Anders has already shown his versatility through his black type winners.

The Shane and Cassie Oxlade-trained Brave Hustler appears to fit more into Anders' expected mould with his two sprinting wins, but the stallion's other two stakes winners have shone over middle to longer distances.

Anders' performers are headed by Single Choice, the three-year-old bought by his trainer Matt Cumani and the NZB Ready To Run Sale. The gelding kicked off in orthodox fashion, with his first two wins coming over 1200 and 1300 metres last spring, but he made his stakes breakthrough over 1800 metres in February in Caulfield's Autumn Classic (Gr 2, 1800m).

That came two weeks after John Blacker's filly Daytona Diva became Anders' first black type victor, taking Hobart's Strutt Stakes (Listed, 2020m).

Single Choice stepped things up even further by winning Caulfield's Galilee Series

Final (Listed, 2400m), and again at the top level at his next start when an unlucky fourth in the South Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2500m).

The gelding was beaten 1.3 lengths on a Soft 7 that day when rider Jamie Mott lost position and covered extra territory in seeking better going out wide before the home turn - in hindsight a questionable move.

Given the second and third horses stuck close to the rail, Anders could well have a Group 1 winner by now if Single Choice and Mott had stayed where they were.

Still, Single Choice looks likely to have a chance to atone for that defeat in the Queensland Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) at Eagle Farm on May 30. Success there, alongside a likely Brisbane carnival mission for Brave Hustler, would indeed end the second season on a huge high for Anders, who's achieving a good deal more than might be suggested by his 2025 book of mares and 2026 service fee - not to mention his background in speed.

"He's tracking along nicely and building a good bit of momentum, and he presents as a great value option really," Widden Stud owner Antony Thompson told ANZ News.

"He's got three stakes winners now so he's going pretty well for this season. He had a nice winner in Hong Kong on Saturday night, and he's had a couple in New Zealand as well.

"It's early days but it's great to be getting stakes winners and stakes horses, and horses who are doing the job."

Anders now has three stakes winners in

Australia from 92 runners at a fair 3.7 per cent, just below the widely-applied minimum pass mark of 4 per cent, and five stakes horses overall from 104 starters.

He had two representatives in the David Coles Stakes in Brave Hustler and Vandaross, who's Group 3-placed.

In New Zealand, Anders has three winners from only six runners, including the twice-Group placed two-year-old Parfait Dimanche, while Effortless Win became his first Hong Kong victor on Saturday amid two runners in the territory.

His winners are almost evenly split along gender lines, with 19 males and 17 fillies.

And he's built momentum after a quiet initial campaign with runners in 2024-25, when he finished 14th among first-season sires with seven winners from 31 starters.

"You never really know what to expect, but he's a horse who really excelled as a three-year-old," said Thompson, tipping a fuller book for Anders this spring.

"It's a competitive market. A lot of people sit and wait and see on first and second-season sires, and wait for it to happen. **Continued on page 4**

“But now with Anders, it’s certainly happening. Like Not A Single Doubt, a lot of these stallions come into their own with a little bit of time and a few books under their belt.”

Widden signed Anders up keen to exploit some Not A Single Doubt blood - that which was represented nearby at Newgate Farm in fairly stunning fashion by the sensational but sub-fertile Extreme Choice.

“Your hopes and expectations when you sign stallions up are that they’ll be good sires. Anders was a fairly electric racehorse and he showed plenty. And with the job Not A Single Doubt has done, and his sons are doing, I guess that’s something you want to tap into. That was a large part of our motivation.

“Not A Single Doubt has a pretty handy one in Extreme Choice. That’s the sort of horse you’re obviously hoping to emulate - albeit with a bit more fertility, which Anders certainly does have. We’re not there yet of course, but with

some nice stakes winners coming it’s nice to see him doing the job.”

Anders was well patronised at first with books of 184 and 169 mares at his starting fee of \$16,500. He then covered 91 and 98 mares in 2023 and 2024 - the latter of which featured an 81.2 per cent fertility rate - before the market sat back and waited after his relatively quiet first season of runners, with just 21 mares covered in 2025.

Thompson, however, is anticipating considerably more interest this year in Anders, whose third crop of yearlings averaged \$76,000 through 14 sold this year, compared to \$41,600 from 45 sold in 2025.

“He’s gathering momentum. We’ve had a fair few enquiries for him this spring, and I definitely think people will see him as a good value stallion,” he said.

“For people looking for a good looking, fast horse who’s not too big, I think he’s a great choice in the value hole.”

As for the stamina of a couple of Anders’

stakes winners, Thompson was - pleasantly - as surprised as anyone.

“To get a 2400-metre winner in Single Choice, who’s out of a Sebring mare who’s out of an Anabaa mare, we probably didn’t expect to see Matt Cumani produce a horse like that,” said Thompson, noting some stamina in Single Choice’s female line.

“But it does show the stallion can have some versatility when put to different mares.”

Cumani - quickly locked in as an Anders fan who bought another of the stallion’s sons at the Inglis Premier Yearling Sale this year for \$200,000 - agrees.

“He’s starting to show a bit, and when he’s showing versatility like that, you’d think that if he gets better quality mares he’ll do better as well,” said Cumani, who’s green-lighting a Queensland Derby tilt for Single Choice at this point.

“At the moment we’re definitely aiming for it. He seems to have come through the SA derby really well, so we’ll make plans to get him to Brisbane.”

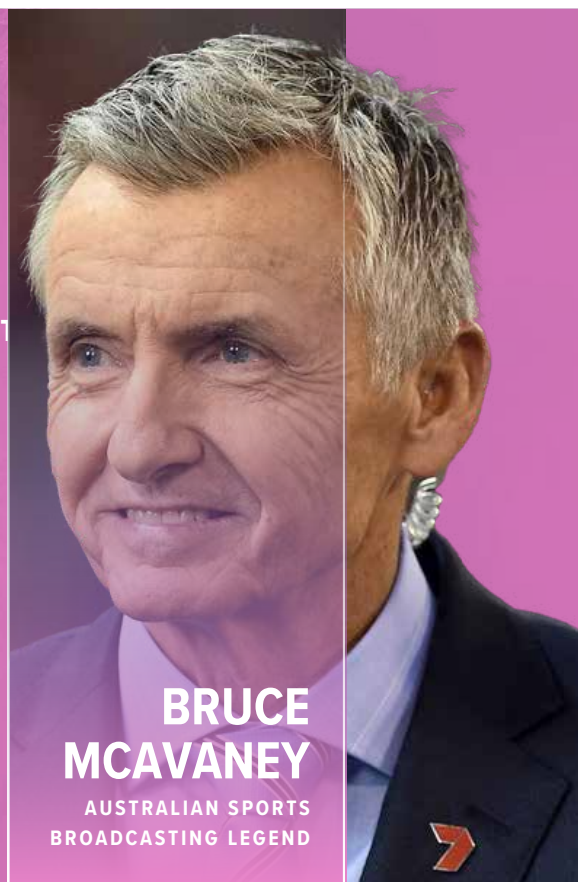

Home Affairs adds tenth winner as Home Tomurra scores at Sunshine Coast

Champion freshman sire elect Home Affairs (I Am Invincible) continued his remarkable season on Sunday when Home Tomurra became his tenth individual winner with victory at the Sunshine Coast. Fittingly, the colt was bred and sold by Torryburn Stud, the nursery which also bred Home Affairs before selling the future dual Group 1-winning sprinter to Tom Magnier for \$875,000 at the 2020 Inglis Australian Easter Yearling sale. Home Tomurra was having his second start in the 1000-metre maiden after finishing third on debut at Doomben last month. Ridden by Daniel Moor, the colt took time to wind up before surging late to score by a head, suggesting a rise in trip

will suit. Purchased by his trainer Henry Dwyer for \$130,000 from the Torryburn draft at the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale, Home Tomurra is one of five winners from six foals to race out of the Lonhro (Octagonal) mare Apamurra, an imported Godolphin-bred half-sister to influential producer Essaouira (Exceed And Excel), the dam of Group 1 winners Alizee (Sepoy) and Astern (Medaglia D'Oro). Apamurra has continued her association with Coolmore, producing a weanling filly by Shinzo (Snitzel) and visiting Storm Boy (Justify) last spring. Home Affairs now has more than A\$4.2 million in progeny earnings in Australia this season, surpassing the previous first-season sire earnings benchmark set by Too Darn Hot (Dubawi) in 2024. The Coolmore stallion's outstanding debut season has been reflected in his increased 2026 service fee of \$176,000 (inc GST).

Queensland Derby beckons for Accidental Bid

Accidental Bid (Phoenix Of Spain) is set to continue on a Queensland Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) path after missing a run in the South Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2500m) earlier this month. The Ciaron Maher-trained colt is entered for Saturday's Rough Habit Plate (Gr 3, 2000m) at Doomben, which shapes as his lead-up to the Queensland Classic at Eagle Farm on May

30. Accidental Bid was favourite for the South Australian Derby at Morphettville but failed to gain a start after being left as first emergency at acceptance time. There remains some concern within the stable that the lightly raced colt could again struggle to secure a place in the field on Saturday, potentially complicating his Queensland Derby preparation. The UK-bred three-year-old has made an encouraging start to his Australian career, winning both starts at Pakenham over 1600 and 2000 metres respectively. Maher's national assistant trainer Jack Turnbull said the gelding had continued to progress despite missing his Adelaide assignment. "We've been able to get work into him, factoring in the travel," Turnbull said. "He did well condition-wise without running in the South Australian Derby, so we were happy to gallop him knowing he was going to travel twice in a short period." Turnbull said Accidental Bid had pleased the stable working in the reverse direction and was expected to take improvement from Saturday's run should he gain a start. "I think he'll be spot on for his next race and then improve again for the Derby trip," he said. Despite the likelihood of missing a run in Adelaide, Maher still elected to travel the colt south in the hope of gaining a late start. "Ciaron was happy to have the travel as it does bring them on and he's a placid colt," Turnbull said.

Monopolistic surges into Queensland Derby contention

Monopolistic (Savabeel) stamped himself a genuine Queensland Derby contender with a powerful finishing display at Gosford on Saturday. The New Zealand-bred gelding unleashed a brilliant late burst to capture the card's Benchmark 78 Handicap (2100m), recording his third win from seven starts for trainer Chris Waller. Ridden by Andrew Atkins, Monopolistic settled near the tail of the 16-horse field before charging home down the outside to overhaul fellow New Zealand-bred King Pedro (Eminent) and score by a neck. "He's heading towards a Queensland Derby and just needs a bit of confidence," Waller said. "He has the ability." The victory continued the progressive colt's rise after he resumed this preparation with placings in strong company, including appearances in the Carbine Club Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m) and Frank Packer Plate (Gr 3, 2000m). Purchased for \$500,000 from Windsor Park Stud's draft at the 2024 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale, Monopolistic is raced by a high-profile ownership group featuring Newgate Farm, China Horse Club and Go Bloodstock. A brother to Listed winner Hindaam, Monopolistic is by Hall of Fame sire Savabeel (Zabeel) and out of the Fastnet Rock (Daneshill) mare Bayrock, herself a sister to Group 1-winning sprinter and sire Merchant Navy. The family also includes Group 1 winner Joliestar (Zoustar). TAB assessors reacted swiftly to Saturday's performance, installing Monopolistic as a \$7 third favourite for the Queensland Derby at Eagle Farm on May 30.

Linebacker, Napoleonic split as Stradbroke plans take shape

Tom Charlton will send stablemates Linebacker (Super Seth) and Napoleonic (Wootton Bassett) down separate paths this weekend as both geldings build towards the Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1400m). Linebacker is

expected to head to Scone for the Luskin Star Stakes (Listed, 1300m), while Napoleonic is set to resume in the Doomben 10,000 (Gr 1, 1200m) in Queensland. "He [Linebacker] is nominated for both, and we can think about it, but he will probably go to Scone and Napoleonic will go to Queensland," Charlton said. "With Linebacker, 1300 is a distance he's very effective at. He will enjoy Scone and if we can get a bit of confidence in him, we can get him to the Stradbroke." The Randwick Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) winner mixed it with elite company during the autumn, including placings behind Joliestar (Zoustar) and Autumn Glow (The Autumn Sun) before finishing sixth in the Doncaster Mile (Gr 1, 1600m). Charlton believes the gelding will benefit from a slight freshen-up and a drop back in trip. "He might appreciate a freshen up and coming back to that 1300 and 1400 metres," he said. Meanwhile, Napoleonic has trialled strongly ahead of his return and is set to follow a Queensland pathway through the Doomben 10,000 and Fred Best Classic (Gr 3, 1400m). "He's still improving and developing, and his trial is indicative he has improved again," Charlton said. "James McDonald is riding him, so clearly he thinks he's capable of winning."

Changingoftheguard eyes Ramsden despite secured Cup berth

Changingoftheguard (Galileo) already has a guaranteed place in the 2026 Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m), but trainer Kris Lees is still set to press on with a start in Saturday's Andrew

Ramsden Stakes (Listed, 2800m) at Flemington. The Newcastle-trained stayer secured his Melbourne Cup qualification with a surprise victory in the Sydney Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) at Randwick, but Lees said the Andrew Ramsden remained a logical stepping stone towards a Brisbane winter campaign centred around the Brisbane Cup (Gr 2, 3200m) on June 13. Although sent out a \$51 outsider in the Sydney Cup, Lees said the performance was not entirely unexpected given the gelding's prior form at the highest level. "He finished ninth in last year's Melbourne Cup which was a creditable effort," Lees told Racing.com. "In the lead-up to the Sydney Cup he struck a couple of wet tracks which weren't to his liking. I would say it was a pleasant surprise and not a huge shock, he turned his form around." Changingoftheguard tuned up for Saturday's assignment with a recent Newcastle 'tick over trial'. "He pleased us and he's in good order to run a forward race in the Ramsden," Lees said. Regular rider Jason Collett is unavailable due to commitments at Scone, paving the way for Declan Bates to take the mount. "He's an on-pace horse. He puts himself on the speed and gets his chance from there. Declan should suit him," Lees said. The Andrew Ramsden has carried Melbourne Cup exemption status since 2019, with previous winners including Steel Prince (Nathaniel), Oceanex (Ocean Park) and The Map (Alpine Eagle) going on to contest the Cup later that year.

Queensland campaign shelved for Wangoom winner Oliveanotherday

Tom Dabernig has opted against chasing Queensland winter carnival riches with emerging sprinter Oliveanotherday (Nicconi), with the gelding instead headed for a short break ahead of a spring campaign. The gelding stamped himself as one of the country's most promising young sprinters when becoming the first three-year-old since Plush Embassy (Plush)

in 1989 to win the Wangoom Handicap (Listed, 1200m) at Warrnambool on Wednesday. Despite holding nominations for the Doomben 10,000, Kingsford Smith Cup (Gr 1, 1300m) and Stradbroke Handicap, Dabernig confirmed the gelding has already been sent to the paddock. "He's gone to the paddock for a four-week spell," Dabernig told Racing.com. "He will be back for the early part of the spring, possibly first-up in the Regal Roller Stakes [Listed, 1200m] at Caulfield." Ridden by Harry Coffey, Oliveanotherday produced a dominant display in the Wangoom, scoring by 2.5 lengths and extending his record to five wins and a second from seven starts. Dabernig said the stable had always held the gelding in high regard. "We've actually known that he's had a stack of ability, but he just keeps on improving," he said. "The main sprint of the carnival, I really wanted to be part of it. I was feeling the pressure coming into it, with the three-year-old in the race, but that's what good horses do, just better than the opposition." Oliveanotherday was unbeaten in four starts during his latest campaign and Dabernig believes there is still more to come. "I'd say there's another couple of decent wins in him for sure," he said.

Keatings juggling busy schedule as Zoucat chases another win

Apprentice jockey Coriah Keatings will continue a hectic run of interstate riding commitments when she heads to Corowa on Monday following recent success across multiple states. Keatings has regularly travelled to Queensland in recent weeks to ride Spicy Lu (Tagaloo) and All Adore (Harry Angel) to victory, while also returning home to partners winners including Hip Hip Ole (Ole Kirk), Vinari (Menari), Toes In The Water (Maurice) and Zoucat (Zoustar). "It has been busy, but my boss Nick Olive and the owners of Spicy Lu and All Adore have been great to give me these opportunities," Keatings told Racing NSW. The

apprentice will ride five horses at Corowa, including Matthew Kelley-trained mare Zoucat in the Benchmark 58 (1200m) before further meetings at Moruya and Bathurst. Zoucat heads into Monday's assignment chasing three consecutive victories after resuming with a narrow win at Queanbeyan last month over 1200 metres. The daughter of Zoustar (Northern Meteor) had previously broken her maiden at Sapphire Coast before a six-month spell and Kelley believes she has improved since returning. "She is very fit, but has still improved a bit off that first-up run," Kelley said. "Corowa is the ideal race for her when she drew alright."

Scone celebrates 80 years with feature two-day carnival

Scone Race Club will celebrate a significant milestone this week as its flagship two-day carnival returns on Friday and Saturday, marking more than 80 years of racing in the heart of Australia's Horse Capital. The carnival hosts NSW's only metropolitan race meeting staged at a country racecourse and again shapes as one of the highlights of the autumn calendar. Friday's program is headlined by the Scone Cup (Listed, 1600m), while Saturday features the Dark Jewel Classic (Gr 3, 1400m)

for fillies and mares. Off the track, the club has continued to expand the raceday experience with upgraded hospitality offerings, food vendors and entertainment across the weekend. Scone Race Club chief executive Jason Hill said the carnival continued to evolve while maintaining its strong community atmosphere. HK: Japanese pair to challenge Romantic Warrior's Triple Crown bid

Two Japanese raiders will attempt to deny Romantic Warrior (Acclamation) in his quest for more Hong Kong racing history when the champion chases the final leg of the Triple Crown at Sha Tin later this month. Deep Monster (Deep Impact) and Rousham Park (Harbinger) are both set to line up in the Champions & Chater Cup (Gr 1, 2400m) on May 24, where Romantic Warrior will bid to complete the prestigious series. The Danny Shum-trained star has already captured the Stewards' Cup (Gr 1, 1600m) and Hong Kong Gold Cup (Gr 1, 2000m) this season, continuing his dominance on home soil. Deep Monster heads to Hong Kong off a successful campaign in Qatar earlier this year, while Rousham Park is no stranger to international travel. The Japanese galloper finished fifth behind Romantic Warrior in last year's Hong Kong Cup (Gr 1, 2000m), has previously placed at the Breeders' Cup and most recently finished midfield in the Queen Elizabeth Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) at Randwick. While Romantic Warrior has been virtually untouchable at distances up to 2000 metres, the 2400-metre journey remains a slight query. The seven-year-old has raced at the trip only once

previously, when narrowly beaten by Russian Emperor (Galileo) in the 2023 edition of the Champions & Chater Cup - the last time he was defeated in Hong Kong. Should Romantic Warrior prevail, he would join River Verdon (Be My Native) and Voyage Bubble (Deep Field) as the only horses to complete Hong Kong's Triple Crown.

International

Six for Sea The Moon

Rayif (3 c ex Rayisa by Holy Roman Emperor) provided Lanwades Stud sire Sea The Moon (Sea The Stars) with his sixth individual Group 1 winner when he produced a powerful finishing burst to land Sunday's Poule d'Essai Des Poulains (Gr 1, 1600m) at Longchamp. The latest Classic winner for the Aga Khan Studs and trainer Francis Graffard, the colt was ridden by Mikhael Barzalona and reversed Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere (Gr 1, 1400m) form with hot favourite Puerto Rico (Wootton Bassett), who faded into fourth after defeating Rayif in October. Godolphin's Komorebi (Pinatubo) finished a length second under William Buick, while the Karl Burke-trained Hankelow (Night Of Thunder) was the leading British or Irish-trained runner in third. Rayif had won both starts this season entering the French Guineas and was providing a notable Group race double on the card for Graffard, Barzalona and the Aga Khan operation after his half-sister Rayevka (Blue Point) captured the Prix de Saint-Georges (Gr 3, 1000m). Rayif now heads towards Royal Ascot, where he holds an entry for the St James's Palace Stakes (Gr 1, 1m). Sea The Moon stands at a fee of £20,000 (approx. AU\$37,606).

FR: Diamond Necklace shines in Poule d'Essai Des Pouliches

Unbeaten St Mark's Basilica (Siyouni) filly Diamond Necklace gave trainer Aidan O'Brien a first victory in the Poule d'Essai Des Pouliches

(Gr 1, 1600m) in 25 years when powering clear in Sunday's French 1,000 Guineas at Longchamp on her seasonal reappearance. Ridden by Ryan Moore, the hot favourite travelled strongly throughout before quickening along the inside in the straight to comfortably account for The Last Dance (Iffraaj) and Green Spirit (Kingman) in testing ground, scoring by three lengths and extending her unbeaten record to four, now including two Group 1 wins. The win completed a European Classic double for O'Brien following True Love's (No Nay Never) victory in the 1,000 Guineas at Newmarket a week earlier and came after stablemate Puerto Rico finished fourth in the preceding Poule d'Essai Des Poulains. "I'm delighted, Ryan gave her a brilliant ride," O'Brien said. "She's like her dad as she has improved from two to three. She was very classy last year and she's got a lot of natural ability. We had it in our heads she'd be a filly for either the Prix de Diane or the Oaks. We thought she could get a mile and a quarter and maybe even further, so she's very exciting."

Third for Contrail

Undefeated Japanese Triple Crown winner Contrail (Deep Impact) sired his third individual stakes winner when Congestus (3 c ex Kirramosa, by Alamosa) announced himself as a potential star in landing Saturday's Kyoto Shimbun Hai (Gr 2, 2100m) at Kyoto. Trained by Tomokazu Takano, the three-year-old colt broke cleanly and settled in midfield under Atsuya Nishimura. Swinging wide at the fourth turn, he began to launch his challenge and steadily reeled in race favourite Bereshit (Epiphaneia) to score by a neck in the 2100-metre Derby trial. The unfancied Radiant Star (Satono Aladdin) finished another length and three quarters away in third. "The Japanese Derby is definitely something to look forward to," Nishimura said. "He was very impressive." Congestus races in the Silk Racing colours having been bred by Northern Farm out of 2013 VRC Oaks (Gr 1, 2500m) winner Kirramosa

(Real Steel) another length and a quarter away in third. Rodeo Drive took his record to three wins from four starts, his sole defeat coming in the New Zealand Trophy (Gr 2, 1600m) on April 11. Bred by Northern Racing, he is one of five winners out of Snitzel (Redoute's Choice) mare Beverly Hills. Saturnalia stands for 10,000,000 JPY (approx. AU\$88,000).

42 for Nyquist

Growth Equity (3 c ex My Dear Venezuela, by Wildcat Heir) became the 42nd individual stakes winner for Darley stallion Nyquist (Uncle Mo) when he claimed Saturday's Peter Pan Stakes (Gr 3, 9f) at Aqueduct. The Chad Brown-trained colt drew away to a two-length victory

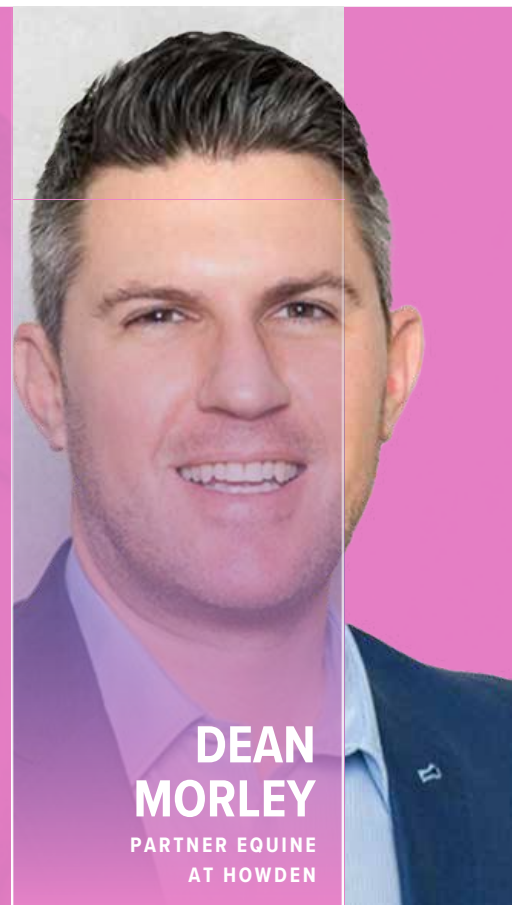
in the Grade 3 contest for three-year-olds, defeating Talk To Me Jimmy (Modernist) with fellow Modernist (Uncle Mo) colt Trendsetter in third. The victory, which secured Growth Equity free entry for the Belmont Stakes (Gr 1, 10f) – to be held at Saratoga this year – continued the colt's progressive rise after he entered the Peter Pan off just three starts in maiden company, having placed over six and seven furlongs before breaking through over a one-turn mile. 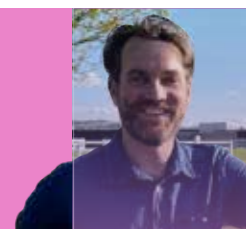

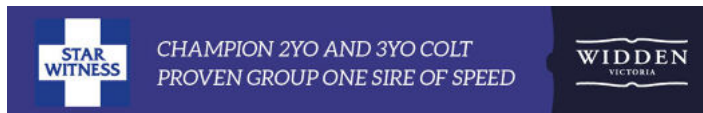

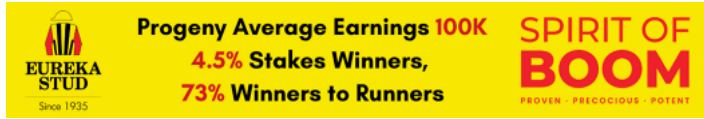
