Basilinna on the road to redemption

Twelve months after winning a Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) golden ticket which she was ultimately unable to cash in due to injury, Basilinna (Staphanos) is out for redemption at Flemington this Saturday when the mare defends her crown in the Andrew Ramsden Stakes (Listed, 2800m).

Bone chips detected in Basilinna's near fore fetlock on the eve of the 2025 Spring Carnival crushed the hopes of her connections after she had earned entry to Australia's most iconic

race with a gallant staying performance in the Andrew Ramsden, but co-trainer Emma-Lee Browne is praying the racing gods are prepared to grant her homebred a second chance.

The mare's late mother So Royal (Shinko King) was purchased as a present for Browne by her husband and training partner David, and that \$500 outlay has reaped the richest of rewards with Basilinna collecting three wins and four stakes placings and the Brownes selling her younger sister, last-start city winner Shangri La Impact, for \$60,000 at the 2023 Magic Millions Gold Coast National Yearling Sale.

Cont. from page 2 Unlike racehorses, dreams are free and after Basilinna showed promising glimpses of her old form with a fast-finishing sixth in unsuitably attritional conditions in the Warrnambool Cup (Listed, 2350m), the priceless prospect of gaining another shot at the Melbourne Cup feels within tantalising reach for her large ownership group.

“On paper her recent form doesn’t look as good as it did this time last year, but her higher rating has meant that we’ve had to run her in much harder races so I think she’s probably going just as well as she was heading into the Andrew Ramsden,” Emma-Lee Browne told ANZ News.

“She’s crying out for the rise in distance now and we think we’ve got her fitness levels right where they need to be for Saturday. She’s got a great constitution, that’s probably her biggest asset so even though she had quite a tough run from a wide draw on a gluey track at Warrnambool, she bounced through it really

well. She’s a big mare so it took a while to get her back up to full fitness after she had all that time off, but we’re there now and I think she’s ready to run another big race on Saturday.

“It was obviously really exciting for us and the ownership group to win the Melbourne Cup ticket last year, it was definitely the highlight of our career so it was a real shame that we weren’t able to use it. It was always the plan to give her a long break and bring her back in the autumn with a view to targeting this race again, so hopefully the plan can come off on Saturday.”

With Basilinna only likely to remain in training for one more season, the breeding barn beckons in the near future – not least as Browne is convinced her sire Staphanos (Deep Impact) will soon be making his presence felt on this side of the Tasman Sea.

To date, Staphanos’ better performers have all been fillies and mares, with his daughter Pignan – who is part-owned by legendary New Zealand rugby full-back Christian Cullen – putting the Novara Park resident’s name up in

lights when she won the Sires’ Produce Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) in 2023 as a juvenile.

His current pin-up girl – other than Basilinna – is Special Sakura, who recently chased home Roger James and Robert Wellwood’s smart mare **Continued on page 5**

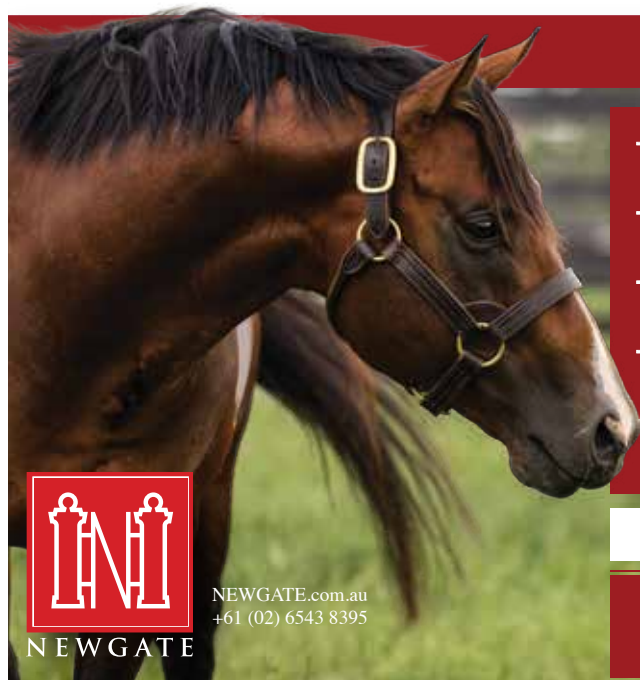

Continued from page 3 She's A Dealer (Ace High) in the NZ Thoroughbred Breeders' Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m), having previously broken through at Listed level in the Fulton Family Stakes (1500m).

Browne freely admits she initially only turned to Staphanos as a cut-price option for So Royal because she couldn't afford the service fee commanded by another son of Deep Impact (Sunday Silence), Rich Hill Stud's proven performer Satono Aladdin. But she has since become an avid admirer of his progeny, and has happily returned to the well on numerous occasions.

"I really like Staphanos as a stallion, he's going great guns and I do think you're going to start seeing him have a bigger impact over here in Australia," said Browne, who also revealed that stakes-winning sprinter McGaw (I Am Immortal) had returned to the stables at the start of the week.

"We just sold his filly [stakes-placed Just Kick] for a good price [\$360,000] at the

Chairman's Sale, and we've got some more of his progeny that we have a decent opinion of. We bought a lovely Staphanos filly for under \$200,000 from Lime Country at the Easter Sale, so with Basilinna likely to be sold as a breeding proposition next year, we're hoping she can step up and take her place.

"He usually produces strong staying types so you do have to be quite patient with his progeny, but if you're prepared to bide your time you're generally going to get the rewards. Basilinna's younger sister is building a very good record, she recently won a race in town over 1800 metres on ANZAC Day so she's been a good buy for her owners and obviously our

mare has taken her connections on a great ride.

"We actually had her entered for the Chairman's Sale last year, because her form has started to taper off a little bit towards the end of her previous prep. But then she came back in great order in the autumn last year, so we decided to pull her out of the sale. I'm very glad we did because we've had a lot of fun with her since then, and hopefully there's more to come - starting on Saturday."

11 for Home Affairs

Coolmore's first-season sire Home Affairs (I Am Invincible) chalked up his 11th individual winner when Home Invasion (2 f ex Catwalk by Foxwedge) scored at the second time of asking in a 1000-metre maiden at Bendigo on Wednesday. Ridden by Jordan Childs for Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott, the filly was dropping back in grade following a debut fifth in the Gimcrack Stakes (Gr 3, 1000m) and defeated Exacting Standard (I Am Invincible) by a half-length. There was a further 1.3 lengths back to Oceans Blue (Bivouac) in third. "She was primed coming in here today. Her last jump out at Werribee was really good and the team came here confident. I'm glad she could deliver," said Jordan Childs. "She's shown good speed in her jump outs and in her previous start as well, so we wanted to use that speed and her race experience today. First time going Melbourne way, it's always beneficial when they can find the rail as it just helps guide them a little bit better, so when she jumped so well, I had no hesitation going to the front. Her determination and her will to win will take her a long way, because you know, every time she goes out, she's going to try 100 per cent. So hopefully she can keep improving and win better races." Cool Archie to stand at \$16,500 as Newhaven confirm fees

Newhaven Park has revealed that Cool Archie (Cool Aza Beel) will stand for an introductory fee of \$16,500 (all fees inc GST) in 2026 after they released their fees on Wednesday.

The JJ Atkins Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m)-winning juvenile was confirmed to be returning to his place of birth in March alongside his father Cool Aza Beel (Savabeel).

In completing his BRC Sires' Produce (Gr 2, 1400m)-JJ Atkins double, Cool Archie mirrored the achievement of Broadsideing (Too Darn Hot) the previous season and looks sure to be popular with breeders.

"There have been very few two-year-olds capable of putting together five wins in succession, four of those being long-established Queensland stakes races, and for me that is one of his major selling points," Newhaven principal John Kelly said of securing Cool Archie to stand back in March.

"His JJ Atkins win confirmed his credentials as a stallion prospect, and when

it became clear his racing career had ended, we were very keen to bring him home to Newhaven."

His father, Cool Aza Beel (Savabeel), will see his fee increased to \$22,000 from \$16,500 last season following his son's success on the track and Cool Aza Rene's Group 3 victory back in October.

Another son of Savabeel (Zabeel) standing at \$22,000 will be Mo'unga.

In a vote of confidence from breeders, the dual Group 1 winner attracted more mares in his second season than first, in which he was very well supported resulting in weanlings from the likes of Champion 2YO and 3YO Filly English (Encosta De Lago) as well as Group-winning mares Lavish Girl (Xtravagant), Chabaud (Lookin At Lucky), and imported stakes winner Eminent Victor (Mr. Z).

Rounding out the four-strong roster is Xtravagant (Pentire), another Group 1 winner on the track that has a winners-to-runners ratio of 61.7 per cent, including this season's Group-placed sprinter Mal Coupe.

of Segenhoe Stud at the 2025 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale, Home Invasion is the second winner from three foals to race out of the metro-winning Foxwedge (Fastnet Rock) mare Catwalk, who is herself a sister to stakes winner Fox Swift and a half-sister to the dam of this season's Breeders Plate (Gr 3, 1000m) winner Incognito (Stay Inside). Home Affairs will stand the 2026 breeding season at a fee of \$176,000 (inc GST).

Two for Splintex

Darling View Thoroughbreds stallion Splintex (Snitzel) sired his second individual winner on Wednesday when the Josh Brown-trained She's A Splinter (2 f ex Toni May by Tavistock) scored in a 1200-metre maiden at Pinjarra. Having her fourth start, the filly proved 0.4 lengths too strong for Encroaching (Gold Standard) under rider William Pike, with a further two lengths back to the third-placed Spirit Of Dan (Spirit Of Boom). Purchased by her trainer for \$35,000 out of Darling View at the 2025 Magic Millions Perth Yearling Sale, She's A Splinter is a half-sister to winners Maybe Divine (Divine Prophet) and Tonix (Exceed And Excel) being out of the winning Tavistock (Montjeu) mare Toni May. Splintex, who has also sired two stakes-placed performers to date in They're all sisters and Yamanex, stood the 2025 breeding season at a fee of \$7,700 (inc GST).

Devil Night primed for Doomben 10,000 tilt

Wayne Hawkes believes Devil Night (Extreme Choice) is ready to give a strong account of himself in Saturday's Doomben 10,000 (Gr 1, 1200m), with the Queensland feature a long-range target for the 2025 Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner. The son of Extreme Choice (Not A Single Doubt) announced himself as a leading juvenile when winning the Blue Diamond at just his second start, becoming the first horse since Redoute's Choice (Danahill) to achieve the feat. Hawkes

said the colt's recent form had been stronger than it appeared on paper. "He's going super," Hawkes said. "When he ran third in the William Reid everyone went 'oh, he's going well' and he was always going well, he's just never had much luck and that form has stood up very well." Devil Night was third behind Jigsaw (Manhattan Rain) in the William Reid Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) before finishing runner-up to star filly Tempted (Street Boss) in the Arrowfield Sprint (Gr 3, 1200m) at Randwick last start. The Hawkes stable considered both the Doomben 10,000 and The Goodwood (Gr 1, 1200m), but opted to remain in Queensland given the colt's Sydney base throughout the campaign. "We have set him for this race, we've always had this race in the back of our minds so it's not an afterthought," Hawkes said. "He's got one of the best attitudes in a colt I've ever had." Devil Night, who races in the colours of Yulong and has been announced to stand the 2026 season in the Hunter Valley, has drawn barrier eight with Ben Melham booked to ride.

JJ Atkins target emerges for promising colt Tron Bolt

A tilt at the JJ Atkins (Gr 1, 1600m) is looming for Tron Bolt (Toronado) after the expensive juvenile produced an impressive maiden victory at Randwick's Kensington track on Wednesday. The son of Toronado became the highest-priced colt ever sold through the Inglis Ready2Race Sale when purchased for \$900,000 by Hermitage Thoroughbreds, and trainer Chris Waller said the colt had been aimed

towards Queensland features for some time. "There's the Sires' Produce in Queensland. It's two-and-a-half weeks away, or the same day at Rosehill there's a 1300 [metre race]. It will be one of the two," Waller said. "Ideally, he can win there or run well and go to the JJ Atkins." Tron Bolt had finished third on debut at Kembla Grange in April before stepping sharply forward in Wednesday's Hawaii Five Oh @ Vinery Stud Handicap (1400m). Ridden by James McDonald, the colt powered clear to score by three lengths over Rolling Home, with stablemate Unhinged third. "He was a nice Ready-To-Run horse, and he's impressed us since day one," Waller said. "He is a lovely, scopey horse, that's why I'm thinking a mile." Waller has enjoyed significant success with later-maturing juveniles through the Brisbane winter carnival and is again shaping with a strong hand for this year's JJ Atkins. Alongside Tron Bolt, Clarendon Stakes winner Stormy Marco (Wootton Bassett) and runner-up Nation's League (Snitzel) are also being aimed towards the Eagle Farm feature.

Stakes opportunity for The Black Cloud

Joe Pride believes The Black Cloud (Shamus Award) is well placed to add another stakes victory to her record when she contests Saturday's Bright Shadow Stakes (Listed, 1110m) at Doomben. The mare will accompany stable star Private Eye (Al Maher) to Brisbane, with the multiple Group 1 winner set to line up in the Doomben 10,000 (Gr 1, 1200m). While The Black Cloud will be making her first appearance at Doomben, Pride said her strong travelling record gave him confidence. "She has travelled really well in the past. She's won at Flemington, she's won at Eagle Farm, she has placed at Caulfield," Pride said. "Whenever I've travelled her away she has always raced well." The Black Cloud has won five of her 19 starts, with four victories coming on rain-affected ground, and Pride said conditions on

Saturday looked ideal. “Fresh, short-course, bit of a wet track. she has got all those things in her favour,” he said. “She seems to race best like that.” The Black Cloud resumed in the Galaxy (Gr 1, 1100m) in March, finishing just over a length behind Marhoona (Snitzel), and drops significantly in grade on Saturday after being freshened since. A previous winner at stakes level at Eagle Farm, she has drawn barrier one and will again be partnered by Nash Rawiller. Meanwhile, Pride said Private Eye had pleased him since his first-up third behind stablemates Mazu (Maurice) and King’s Secret (Shalaa) in the Hall Mark Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m). “I couldn’t be happier with him,” Pride said. “It’s a Group One race, they’re never easy, but he’s in great shape.”

Lynch chasing Melbourne Cup dream with Alaiuge

South Australian trainer Garret Lynch will aim to secure a Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) berth when Alaiuge (Sir Prancealot) contests Saturday’s Andrew Ramsden Stakes (Listed, 2800m) at Flemington. The Murray Bridge horseman currently leads the South Australian trainers’ premierships with 65 winners, built largely through extensive travel across metropolitan, provincial and country circuits. “I place them where they can win and if that means if it’s 10 or 11 hours away, I’ll head off,” Lynch said. Saturday’s trip to Flemington comes after Alaiuge provided Lynch with the biggest win of his career in the Port Adelaide Cup (Listed, 2500m) at Morphettville earlier this month. The mare had previously caught the stable’s attention with a strong-finishing fifth in the Adelaide Cup (Gr 2, 3200m). “She ran a really good race in the Adelaide Cup and was just way too far back and finished off really strongly,” Lynch said. “After getting the two miles for the first time, I thought we’d head down this direction and try and qualify for the Melbourne Cup. “Ask any trainer, and their aim is to win the Melbourne Cup, and I’m not

different.” Harry Grace will again ride Alaiuge after partnering her to victory in the Port Adelaide Cup. Following the Ramsden, Lynch said the mare would likely head towards the Sandown Cup (Listed, 3200m).

Future History begins Melbourne Cup campaign in Chairman’s Handicap

Future History (Showcasing) will make his first start for Gregory Hickman in Saturday’s Chairman’s Handicap (Gr 3, 2000m) at Doomben as he begins another Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) campaign. Previously trained by Ciaran Maher, the gelding contested the 2023 Melbourne Cup and joins Hickman after part-owner Adam Carney increased his shareholding. “Adam Carney bought a major share of it and Adam and I are friends, so Adam transferred the horse from Ciaran to me,” Hickman said. Future History heads to Brisbane off a short break after finishing fourth in the Australia Day Cup (Listed, 2400m) at Warwick Farm in January. Prior to that, he had won three consecutive Listed races. Hickman said the stayer had retained residual fitness and pleased through two recent trials. “I think he’s going as well as we can to run first-up, but we’re still learning about the horse,” Hickman said. “He’s travelled up there well. He’s so relaxed and nothing seems to bother him.” Saturday’s result will determine the gelding’s next target, with the Doomben Cup (Gr 1, 2000m) and Tattersall’s Cup (Gr 3, 2400m) among the options. “We’ve roughly mapped out where we’ve got to go to get into the Melbourne Cup, so he’ll do most of his lead-up races to the Cup in Melbourne,” Hickman said. Nash Rawiller retains the ride.

Stakes target next for I Am Carrot

I Am Carrot (Castelvecchio) has all but secured a Brisbane winter carnival campaign after producing an impressive first-up victory on

the Randwick Kensington track on Wednesday. The progressive three-year-old gave emerging trainer Nacim Dilmi his 30th winner for the Domeland operation when taking out the Kia Central Region Dealer Of The Year Handicap (1300m). Dilmi who formerly worked for Godolphin took over as Domeland’s private trainer at the start of the season and has quickly built an impressive strike-rate. “It’s good to get another win out of the way,” Dilmi said. “I don’t want to step up in grade too soon, but he’ll go to Queensland after this and hopefully we can find a nice race for him like the Fred Best Classic (Gr 3, 1400m), or another stakes race towards the end of the Queensland carnival.” Ridden by Jason Collett, I Am Carrot settled off the speed before finishing strongly to defeat Alphard (Street Boss) by three-quarters of a length, with Events (Lonhro) a further length away in third. Dilmi said the decision to geld the son of Castelvecchio (Dundeel) earlier in his three-year-old season had proven pivotal to his development. Since the procedure, I Am Carrot has won three races and finished runner-up twice from five starts. “Obviously if the field is a bit strong or he needs more time I won’t rush him into it, but so far he is doing the right things to put his hand up for Queensland,” Dilmi said. The Fred Best Classic is scheduled for Eagle Farm on May 30.

McEvoy partnered Athanatos (I Am Immortal) to victory in The Coast (Listed, 1600m) and King Of Roseau (Capitalist) in the Takeover Target Stakes (Listed, 1100m), and will begin his Scone assignments aboard War Eternal (Pierro) in Friday's Scone Cup (Listed, 1600m). Among his key Saturday rides are Our Kobison (Kobayashi) in the Ortensia Stakes (Listed, 1100m) and Lindsay Park filly La Gitana (Home Affairs) in the Woodlands Stakes (Listed, 1100m). Our Kobison once featured in Everest discussions after winning six of his first 10 starts and later finishing runner-up to Joliestar (Zoustar) in the Show County Quality (Gr 3, 1200m). The gelding resumed with a narrow second to Point And Shoot (Blue Point) before finishing fifth in the Hawkesbury Gold Rush. "He was really good first-up when he was just nosed out," McEvoy said. "It wouldn't surprise me to see him bounce back to being very competitive on the weekend." McEvoy also expects La Gitana to perform strongly on her NSW debut after placing at both starts in Victoria at stakes level. "She's got stakes form, so she's got to be a chance," he said. McEvoy will also partner Casserousse (Exceed And Excel), Harlem Queen (Brutal) and Captain Furai (Toronado) across the carnival's remaining feature races.

SA racing industry economic report released

South Australia's racing industry generated \$729.3 million for the state economy in 2024/25 and supported more than 5,000 full-time equivalent jobs, according to a new industry report released this week. Compiled by sports industry specialists IER on behalf of the state's thoroughbred, greyhound and harness racing codes, the report highlighted racing's ongoing economic, employment and community impact across metropolitan and regional South Australia. The industry recorded a total value-added contribution of \$729.3 million, including

Champion Three-Year-Old Racehorse was awarded to Sheza Alibi (Saxon Warrior), whose exceptional three-year-old season included five consecutive Group wins, including dominant displays in the Randwick Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) and Doncaster Mile (Gr 1, 1600m). The filly came out on top in this category over two star opponents in Beiwacht (Bivouac) and Autumn Boy (The Autumn Sun).

The Champion Racehorse 4YO+ was awarded to Joliestar (Zoustar), who took her elite-level tally to five this season, winning the Canterbury Stakes (Gr 1, 1300m) and TJ Smith Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m). She defeated fellow Group 1 winners Giga Kick (Scissor Kick) and Lazzura (Snitzel) to land the gong.

Champion First Season Sire was awarded to Coolmore's Home Affairs (I Am Invincible). The first-season sire has produced four individual stakes winners and a further four stakes placegetters in his maiden season at stud, highlighted by Golden Slipper-winning colt Guest House.

Champion Sire was awarded to late Arrowfield Stud stalwart Snitzel. The son of Redoute's Choice's (Danahill) presence

was felt through every major carnival as he added five new individual Group 1 winners to his record in Baraqiel, Campione D'Italia, Fireball, Lazzura and Transatlantic, as well as further elite success for his daughter Marhoona. Also a formidable producer of sires, his sons Sword Of State and Wild Ruler sired Group winners at their first season at stud.

The Champion Broodmare was awarded to Shadow (Medaglia D'Oro), owned by Etak Thoroughbreds and a resident of Coolmore. Shadow is the dam of Group 1-winning three-year-old filly Apocalyptic and Hidrix, a Group 3 winner on debut as a two-year-old this season. The pair are both sired by Newgate's remarkable sire Extreme Choice.

\$589.1 million in direct racing industry expenditure and a further \$434.6 million in indirect flow-on effects. Thoroughbred racing accounted for the largest share of the economic impact at \$519.1 million, while greyhound racing contributed \$131.2 million and harness racing \$79 million. Employment across the industry also continued to grow, with direct full-time equivalent roles increasing more than three per cent to 2,914, while total direct and indirect employment rose to 5,041 FTE positions. More than 16,000 people participated in the industry as employees, participants or volunteers during the year, while attendances across the state's 805 race meetings totalled 266,483. The report also reinforced racing's importance to regional communities, with 36 per cent of the industry's economic contribution generated in regional South Australia and more than half of all participants based outside metropolitan areas. Rob Rorrison said the findings reflected racing's growing strength across the state. "This strength is being reflected at every level of thoroughbred racing in South Australia, including in our field sizes, which, at 10.8 starters per race, are the best in the nation," Rorrison said. "The strategic path we are taking to grow our industry is benefiting not only racing but also our state as a whole." The report also highlighted racing's broader social contribution, with clubs supporting more than 120 community organisations and charities through donations, events and facility use. "He galloped really well the other day and it's a strong maiden, but he'll be competitive," Meadows said. Jonathan Riddell retains the ride on Derrick after indicating the gelding would appreciate improved footing.

It's In The Blood

Naifah

The emerging cross of multiple champion sires I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit) over Snitzel (Redoute's Choice) has been in the news lately.

Last Thursday night it set bells ringing when two-year-old Chayan (I Am Invincible) became the second most expensive graduate of an Australian breeding stock auction, going for \$5.6 million to Coolmore's Tom Magnier after a marathon bidding duel with Yulong at the Inglis Chairman's Sale.

The Team Archibald-trained filly became a stakes winner for the cross in March with a three-length romp in Randwick's Reisling Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) that largely spurred her dizzying sale price.

Less than two days after her sale the cross was at it again, with Naifah (I Am Invincible) leading throughout to take Morphetville's Proud Miss Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) for her black type breakthrough.

'Vinnie' and Snitzel - like Ali and Frazier, or indeed Coolmore and Yulong - the two heavyweights of the modern era. They share seven champion sire titles and with an eighth seemingly on the way as the late Snitzel eyes his fifth one posthumously. They're a pair who go well together.

Sadly, Arrowfield's Snitzel died last June, just short of turning 23, and I Am Invincible will soon turn 22. But with plenty of Snitzel mares out there, the cross is building momentum.

Naifah became the fourth stakes winner by Yarraman Park's flagbearer out of a Snitzel mare from 36 runners at 11 per cent. The cross has seven stakes horses (19.44 per cent) and has borne a hefty 32 winners including its top earner - who's not a stakes winner - in the gelding who won a Rosehill two-year-old handicap as Enforcement before scoring four more times in Hong Kong as Harmony And Rich.

On the reverse, Snitzel over I Am Invincible is also emerging in promising order, with two black type victors from 19 runners, at 10.53 per cent, with the best being Perth's Aurum Belle, a winner of three out of four including a G3 and a Listed.

Bryan Carlson of Emirates Park, which bred Naifah, said part of the attraction in putting her dam Najmah to I Am Invincible was the fact it would avoid doubling Danehill (Danzig), since 'Vinnie' is Danehill-free, hailing from an alternate Danzig (Northern Dancer) line that runs Danzig-Green Desert-Invincible Spirit-I Am Invincible.

Not only is Danehill Snitzel's grandsire, Najmah has Danehill twice at 3m x 4m since her third dam Charley Star (Arena) has him as her grandsire.

I Am Invincible's best nick remains Encosta De Lago (Fairy King), an entirely Danehill-free match-up with a resounding SWTR ratio of

19 per cent, with ten stakes winners from 52 runners headed on earnings by Hawaii Five Oh, and on black type by its sole elite victor Lombardo, who claimed The Goodwood (Gr 1, 1200m).

Street Cry (Machiavellian), also Danehill-free, runs at 20 per cent, but from a smaller sample of 15 runners and three black type victors.

Two strongly Danehill sires sit next at 16 per cent (both three stakes winners from 20 runners) - in Danehill Dancer and his son Choisir.

"I Am Invincible over Snitzel has been working well," Carlson said. "And I think it's going to pop up a fair bit in the near future."

Carlson, however, sees an issue in the near future for breeders with Snitzel mares, with outcross superstar I Am Invincible now in his twilight.

"The biggest thing going forward will be

where do you send your Snitzel mares, if you want to avoid doubling Danehill?" he said of that often mistrusted duplication. "There's so much Danehill in our Australian sires.

"We'll have 'Vinnie' for another couple of years, but after that, we're going to struggle to mate to these top stallions, if you're avoiding Danehill.

"You could start sending them overseas and covering them to southern hemisphere time, but that gets expensive."

As Carlson suggested, Too Darn Hot (Dubawi) could fit the bill, since he's Danehill-free. Likewise those sons of Street Cry in Street Boss and Per Incanto, but they're both 'Vinnie's' age.

The only other active Danehill-free stallions in the top ten of the Australian general sires' list at present are I Am Invincible's son and barnmate Hellbent, who's SWTR ratio is 2.89 per cent, and Written Tycoon (Iglesia), who's about to turn 24.

Harry Angel (Dark Angel), who finished seventh last year and is 13th now, also warrants mention as a possibility.

For now, Emirates Park has been plundering Danehill-free sires, and I Am Invincible in particular, with what's become a particularly rich family that's produced Naifah and its star member, Naifah's elite-winning three-quarter sister Charm Stone (I Am Invincible).

This success saga started when Emirates purchased Najoom (Northern Meteor) as a yearling at Magic Millions Gold Coast in 2013, for \$225,000 from Willow Park Stud. She's turned out to be Naifah's second dam and the mother of Charm Stone, now her stablemate with Price-Kent Jnr, who's won two 1200-metre Group 1s and run third in another, and won two Group 3s.

Najoom was the second foal of Charley Star, who was from the fourth crop of an unfashionable sire but had strong blood from her dam Joleur (Bite The Bullet).

Joleur won only a Goulburn maiden from 23 starts but gave birth to three Listed victors among eight winners from nine runners, Gaze On (Intergaze), Bhutane Dane (Danehill Dancer) and Upon This Rock (Fastnet Rock).

Plus Joleur's Canadian dam Gainesville (Afleet) had two Australian black type winners

in 1998 throw Mica's Pride (Bite The Bullet), who won a Group 3, and, ten years later, the Listed-winning Amah Rock (Fastnet Rock).

"Najoom was from the first crop of Northern Meteor, so we bought her on type really," Carlson said. "She was a very impressive type, and she turned out to be a good performer."

Carrying Emirates' famed green with the white sash for Gai Waterhouse, the chestnut Najoom won five from seven and signed off with her two stakes victories in 2015 - in the Hawkesbury Guineas (Gr 3, 1400m) by 3.8 lengths, and Doomben's Fred Best Classic (Gr 3, 1350) by 3.3 lengths.

After a Gold Coast barrier trial win - by three lengths - she was favourite to claim a coveted top-tier win in the Tatts Tiara (Gr 1, 1400m) but failed to gain a run as third emergency.

"She probably should have won that race, but we'll never know," Carlson said.

Still, she's more than made up for it at stud.

Her first live foal was Najmah (whose first foal is Naifah). Najmah showed decent ability for Team Hawkes, winning her Kembla Grange debut by 3.8 lengths and her second start at Canterbury by two. Two narrow city placings followed before she was found to be short of black type level, retiring after seven starts.

The family's association with I Am Invincible kicked off with Najoom's second foal Najmaty. She won two Listed - in Melbourne at two and Brisbane at three - and ran a Group 2 second in Emirates' colours.

Najoom's third foal, again by 'Vinnie', became her first one offered for sale by Emirates. She fetched no less than \$1.55 million, sold to Sheamus Mills at Magic Millions 2022, and became Charm Stone.

Ultimately, Najoom had eight foals for six fillies, only two of whom were sent by Emirates to auction.

Such an impressive foal was Charm Stone that in 2021, Emirates had no hesitation sending her half-sister Najmah to I Am Invincible for the first mating that's produced Naifah.

They continued the trend a year later by putting Najmah to their own stallion (standing at Newgate Farm) in Tassort, 'Vinnie's' grandson by Brazen Beau. That produced the filly Naadra, who's a city-placed two-year-old with Michael Freedman and who Carlson has

tipped for black type honours.

Emirates did indeed try that Danehill-free Harry Angel for Najmah's third mating, and have a yearling filly named Nigwah to show for it.

Najmah returned to Tassort for her fourth mating, for yet another filly, who's a weanling now, and was sent to a Danehill-free son of Written Tycoon - Ole Kirk - last spring.

Naifah started in Emirates' ownership in the Team McEvoy stable - with an Adelaide Listed second among three starts - before they offered her at last year's Gold Coast Broodmare Sale. She was bought by Silverdale Farm and Andy Williams Bloodstock for \$400,000, and transferred to Charm Stone's trainers, Price and Kent Jnr.

"It was purely a business decision, and I stand by it now," Carlson said. "We just thought, we've got three other sisters out of the mare now, plus we've still got Najoom. And nearly every mare we've got from the family has just had fillies, so we're not short of the blood."

Naifah's pedigree contains one notable bit of inbreeding, with the influential Canny Lad (Bletchingly) in strong positions at 3f x 5f, through two of his best daughters. Cannarelle is the top one, as I Am Invincible's dam, while in the bottom half he's the sire of the great blue hen Shantha's Choice, dam of Snitzel's father Redoute's Choice.

"I think doubling Canny Lad is a good thing, and that obviously brings a doubling of his dam Jesmond Lass, which I like," said Carlson, who tried a similar trick in breeding Liwa (Mulaazem), who won two Perth Listed and been twice Group placed.

Liwa has Jesmond Lass (Lunchtime) in a very direct 4f x 4f - as the third dam of both the father and the mother. (Showing no rule is hard and fast, Liwa also has Danehill doubled decidedly closely, at 3f x 3m!)

Carlson also likes the other notable piece

of inbreeding in Naifah's pedigree, a 5f x 5m of Jesmond Lass's father Lunchtime (Silly Season), who's in the bottom half as the sire of Snitzel's damsire Snippets.

Naifah also carries a 7m x 8m of key US broodmare Lalun (Djeddah), through her two best sons Never Bend (Nasrullah), in Green Desert's female family, and Bold Reason (Hail To Reason), who's in Northern Meteor's paternal half.

Key blue hen Natalma (Native Dancer) takes nine spots in the first nine generations, through only one in the top half, and the most present mare is Selene (Chaucer) with 11 appearances - only one on the dam's side.

The dominant sire is Native Dancer (Polynesian), with 15 mentions, one more than Hyperion (Gainsbrough), while Nearco (Pharos) is, rarely for him, only third with 13.

Interestingly, while double Danehill is not for everyone, three of Morphetville's six stakes winners on Saturday had exactly that.

Desert Lightning (Pride Of Dubai), who took the day's feature The Goodwood, has him at 3f x 4f, in powerful places as the stallion's damsire and the dam's second damsire.

Brave Hustler (Anders), winner of the two-year-old David Coles Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) has Danehill in his statistically weakest form of duplication - double male - at 4m x 4m, also in strong spots as the fourth sire and father of the second damsire.

And Private Legacy (The Autumn Sun) has Danehill loud and clear at 3m x 3f, in the statistically best gender-balanced split, as the third sire and second damsire.

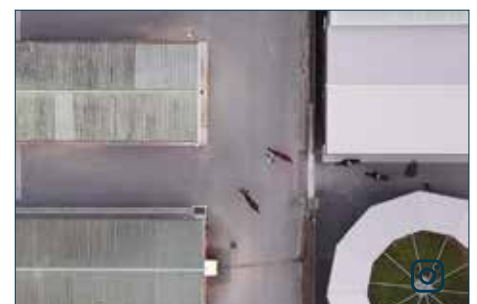
