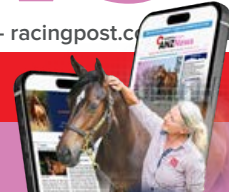

# Tavi Time bidding to go back-to-back in Scone Cup as Lees gears up for big day

**T**rainer Kris Lees has elected to keep Tavi Time (Tavistock) closer to home for the Scone Cup (Listed, 1600m) on Friday afternoon instead of sending him north for the Group 1 Doomben Cup meeting on Saturday.

Tavi Time is on the second line of markets at \$7.50 in a wide-open Scone Cup and he can be the catalyst for some black-type strikes by the stable on Friday and Saturday. Scone Race Club's iconic carnival showcases six black-type events across 18 races with overall prize-money of \$2.27 million.

Lees has followed a winning formula with the son of Tavistock (Montjeu), who was a convincing winner of last year's Scone Cup when racing third-up from a spell. He's duplicating that preparation and looks a big chance to go back-to-back despite giving weight all round with 59 kilograms.

"We entered him for the Doomben Cup and Bernborough Handicap but decided to go again in the Scone Cup," Lees said.

"He could still go up there for another crack at the Lord Mayors Cup in a fortnight and hopefully go one better than his second last year.

**Continued from page 2** “Tavi Time is topweight and that’s a good leveller but I can’t argue with 59 kilograms. He won with 56.5 kilograms last year and then won his second Summer Cup at Randwick in December.

“He’s going extra well and his profile is similar to last year. He wasn’t beaten far in the Hawkesbury Cup last start after Dylan [Gibbons] had to go back from the wide draw but he got home nicely.”

Pencarrow Stud for \$60,000 to Kiltannon Stables at the NZB Karaka Yearling Sale in 2021. He changed hands again when knocked down to Adrian Pazman for \$130,000 at the Inglis Ready2Race Sale later that year.

His dam Guiseppina (Johar) won a Group 1 Telegraph Handicap (1200m) at Trentham and second-dam Battocchi (Success Express) was a Listed winner of the 1997 Ballarat Cup (2200m) and Matriarch Stakes (2000m) at Flemington for Lindsay Park.

Guiseppina has a yearling colt by U S Navy Flag (War Front) that was purchased for \$75,000 by Waikato trainer John Bell at Karaka in January.

Tavi Time has banked over \$1.12 million from ten wins in 30 starts for a partnership managed by Pazman and his other feature wins include the 2024 and 2025 ATC Summer Cups (Gr 3, 2000m) at Randwick.

Only two Scone Cup winners have doubled up the following year since its inception in 1947: Brave Prince (Kenmare) was bred by Stan

Johnson to win in 2000-01 for trainer Sterling Smith, and the Carl Powell-bred Bridge Man (Roy Bridge) won in 1981-82 with trainer Rex Bowdler.

The Scone Cup is also a key qualifying race for the \$3 million the Big Dance (1600m) at Randwick on Melbourne Cup Day. Lees won his first Scone Cup with Rustic Steel (Deep Field) in 2022 and a six-month plan paid off big time in the inaugural The Big Dance for his jubilant owners Ron and Judy Wanless. **Continued on page 4**

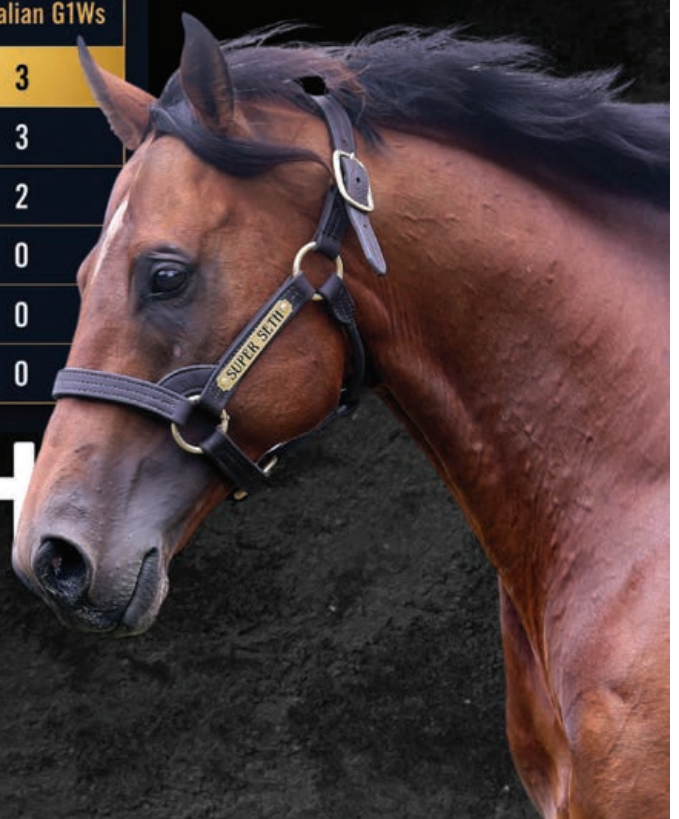

**Continued from page 3** Tavi Time was unplaced in last year's renewal of the Big Dance won by Gringotts (Per Incanto) but had no luck in running. Stewards reported: "Had difficulty obtaining clear running in the early part of the straight. Then steadied near the 150 metres when disappointed for a run between Cranky Harry and Matusalem."

Lees has a strong team engaged at Scone and his black-type candidates on Saturday are Cantiamo (Too Darn Hot), Brudenell (Russian Revolution), Imposant (Epaulette) and Infancy (Wandjina).

"Cantiamo is going well and has trained on nicely since her latest win at Randwick on Anzac Day," Lees reported.

"She will appreciate a good tempo coming back to 1100 metres and has a really good chance in the Denise's Joy Stakes.

"Brudenell has taken improvement from his first-up run at Hawkesbury but has drawn poorly in the Ortensia Stakes. That might not be a disadvantage being the second day of the carnival.

"Imposant is very consistent, and has had a good gap between her second to stablemate Lord Of Biscay in the Provincial-Midway Championships Final at Randwick on April 11. She gets back anyway and just needs some luck in running to be in the finish of the Dark Jewel Classic."

As always, Lees would love to claim another Luskin Star Stakes (Listed, 1300m) named after the superstar sprinter trained by his father Max Lees. He won it in 2017 with Clearly Innocent (Not A Single Doubt) and has Infancy engaged

after she failed to make a \$775,000 reserve at last week's Inglis Chairman's Sale.

"Infancy will definitely line up in the Luskin Star. Her sectionals when she came from well back to finish second in the Sapphire Stakes at Randwick on April 11 were outstanding," Lees said.

"This isn't any easier, but she has drawn a good gate in the big field, and should be able to settle a bit closer."

Scone is the Horse Capital of Australia and it comes alive ahead of a great weekend on the racing calendar. The atmosphere began building earlier this week with the Scone Horse Festival Parade complete with floats, horses, riders, schools, community groups and plenty of festival spirit drawing crowds along Hill, Liverpool, Kelly and Guernsey Streets.

And there was plenty of action indoors last night at the Scone RSL for the official Cup Calcutta after the \$4.40 favourite Formal Display (Too Darn Hot) received a late start from second emergency.

#### Napoleonic lands spot in Doomben 10,000

Three-year-old Napoleonic (Wootton Bassett) has secured a start in Saturday's Doomben 10,000 (Gr 1, 1200m) – allowing connections to press on with their Brisbane winter campaign plans. Trainer Tom Charlton admitted it had been an anxious wait after the colt was initially listed as second emergency for the \$1.5 million sprint, before gaining a start after the withdrawals of Lady Of Camelot (Written Tycoon) and Abounding (Rich Enuff). "It's important because he looks like he's in a big race with a chance," Charlton said. "It has always been the plan, and it's not normally a race where you get a full field. Normally a 103-rated three-year-old gets in, so it was a bit of a spanner in the works. But thankfully,

we're in." Napoleonic has not raced since his competitive performance in the Canterbury Stakes (Gr 1, 1300m) at Randwick in March when finishing eighth, just 1.6 lengths behind winner Joliestar (Zoustar). That run followed second placings in both the Eskimo Prince Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) and Hobartville Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m). He arrived in Brisbane on Thursday after pleasing in a key gallop earlier in the week alongside Linebacker (Super Seth). James McDonald partnered the colt in the gallop and will take the ride in the Doomben 10,000. "We can't fault the preparation thus far," Charlton said. Napoleonic shares the second line of betting at \$6.50 alongside Grafterburners (Graff), with Jimmysstar (Per Incanto) heading the market.

#### Waterhouse and Bott target another JRA Chairman's

Trainers Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott are hoping to uncover another Brisbane winter carnival star in Saturday's JRA Chairman's Handicap (Gr 3, 2000m) at Doomben, a race that launched Sir Delius (Frankel) into Group 1 company last year. Sir Delius won the 2025 edition on his Australian debut before going on to claim three Group 1 victories, including a dominant success in the Queen Elizabeth Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) at Randwick in April. While the stable elected not to bring the now

multiple elite-level winner back to Queensland this season following a demanding autumn, the Waterhouse and Bott team will be represented by Just Fine (Sea The Stars) and Alalcance (Mastercraftsman). The pair completed their final serious work on Tuesday morning with a gallop at Doomben under the watchful eye of Bott. "They worked up as a pair together," Bott told Racing Queensland. "They are just kicking off their campaigns or their winter campaigns here. I've got some more targets in store for them, but they both worked up nicely on Tuesday morning." Just Fine (\$10), to be ridden by Tim Clark, and Alalcance (\$14), who will be partnered by Martin Harley, are both chasing a breakthrough stakes victory for the season after competing consistently in Group company. The stable has enjoyed notable success during the Brisbane winter carnival in recent seasons, with Sir Delius joining feature-race winners including Alligator Blood (All Too Hard), Hawaii Five Oh (I Am Invincible), Knights Order (So You Think) and Converge (Frankel). "It's such a great carnival," Bott said. "Horses continue to come through here and go on and perform, particularly very well through the early part of the spring for us."

Ramsden (Listed, 2800m) at Flemington was never originally part of Zakouma's (Crowded House) preparation, but a luckless run at Flemington on Anzac Day convinced connections to chase a ballot exemption into the Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m). Zakouma had won three straight races before finishing unplaced in a Benchmark 100 contest over 2000 metres at Flemington, where he was trapped on the rail near the rear before finding clear running only late. Rather than heading to the paddock following that effort, connections elected to continue on to the Andrew Ramsden, one of ten races offering direct entry into the Melbourne Cup. Begg said the gelding's latest run had effectively been "a 2000-metre barrier trial," although he questioned the set-weights conditions of Saturday's contest. "He's got to go the distance and he's not well-weighted under the conditions," Begg said. "I don't understand why it's a set-weights race. Outside three-year-old Classic races, I can't think of one, while the winner gets free passage into the Melbourne Cup and then goes back to a handicap." Zakouma has not raced beyond 2000 metres since joining Begg from trainers Pat Carey and Harris Walker, though he did place over 2200 and 2400 metres earlier in his career. Begg expects the tempo to suit and the plan is to ride Zakouma patiently. "What we'll try to do is put him to sleep, give him some clean air, and give him one crack at them," he said.

### Breslin dreaming of scoring Melbourne Cup golden ticket

Awapuni trainer Mike Breslin is daring to dream of a Melbourne Cup start with Crouch (Tarzino) as the gelding prepares to contest Saturday's Andrew Ramsden at Flemington. Named after former England striker Peter Crouch, the six-year-old will attempt to secure a ballot exemption into the Melbourne Cup by winning the Andrew Ramsden, having already proven his staying credentials with consecutive

runner-up finishes in the Wellington Cup (Gr 3, 3200m). Breslin said the gelding had handled the trip across the Tasman well after settling into the Pakenham stable of expat Kiwi trainer Rachael Frost. "It is a long trip," Breslin said. "He has brightened up a lot in the last 48 hours." Crouch heads to Melbourne in career-best form after placings in the Wellington Cup and Awapuni Gold Cup (Gr 2, 2100m) before breaking through in the Hawke's Bay Cup (Listed, 2200m) at Otaki last month. While Saturday's race offers the allure of a Melbourne Cup berth, Breslin said the Sandown Cup (Listed, 3200m) in a fortnight shapes as the gelding's primary Australian target. "Even though this race sounds like a bigger race with more prestige, the Sandown Cup is probably the race he should be able to be very competitive in," he said. "If he wins he's got a golden ticket into the Melbourne Cup. I'm not saying that's my plan and why he's running, but it is there if the best did happen." Crouch will jump from barrier four with Harry Coffey aboard.

### Derby credentials on line for Different Gravy

Trainer Henry Dwyer says Saturday's Trevor Clarke Handicap (2000m) at Flemington will determine whether Different Gravy (Ghaiyyath) presses on toward the Queensland Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) later this month. Dwyer has long held Queensland Derby ambitions for the gelding following his Listed victory over 1800 metres at Flemington on Melbourne Cup Day last spring,

but admitted the three-year-old has yet to show his best form this preparation. Different Gravy resumed with a below-par effort at Caulfield in March before finishing fourth in the Port Adelaide Guineas (Listed, 1800m) at Morphettville last month. "Admittedly we knew he was underdone but I thought he would go better at Caulfield," Dwyer said. "He improved somewhat but still wasn't as good as he can be, so we've left him down here to give ourselves another chance before we pull the trigger and send him to Queensland. I don't think we've seen the best of him this prep." Different Gravy has since won a trial at Caulfield Heath in blinkers, with the headgear to remain on for Saturday's assignment. Dwyer believes the return to Flemington and rise to 2000 metres should suit, despite the gelding conceding significant weight to some progressive rivals, including the Matt Cumani-trained Brave Danza (Brave Smash). "He doesn't necessarily have to win, and I'm not saying he can't, but as long as he finished in the top three or four, I would be confident enough that that would be a good enough run to go to Queensland," he said.

### Concord set to fly at Flemington

Trainer Charlotte Littlefield is keeping expectations in check with promising filly Concord Connie (Contributer) as the three-year-old attempts to back up her explosive Flemington win in Saturday's K A Morrison Handicap (1400m) back at HQ. Concord Connie announced herself as a filly of considerable potential when romping to a six-length victory at Flemington on Anzac Day in slick time at just her third race start. "We're just trying to keep a lid on her at the moment and not get ahead of ourselves," Littlefield said. "She has to back-up that performance before we start jumping up and down, but she's in really good order. She's doing everything you want to see, she's ticked all the boxes, and we've got to get through one more day." Littlefield said the current campaign

was unlikely to extend much further regardless of Saturday's result, with the stable keen to protect the filly ahead of longer-term spring ambitions. "She's a filly that is still quite fragile at times, quite sensitive and I think doing too much at this time will be detrimental to her future," she said. The trainer, who previously handled Group 1 placegetter She's Bulletproof (Shooting To Win), added Concord Connie had pleased in recent work at Pakenham and said the naturally athletic filly had continued to thrive since her dominant last-start success.

### Scone springboard for classy Linebacker

Trainer Tom Charlton believes proven Group 1 performer Linebacker can underline his Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1400m) credentials when he resumes in Saturday's Luskin Star Stakes (Listed, 1300m) at Scone. A Group 1 winner and Silver Eagle (1300m) victor, Linebacker returns with 59 kilos after a six-week freshen-up following his sixth in the Doncaster Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) at Randwick. "He'd want to be running very well, his form suggests he should run well and the way he's going he's not horrendously treated at the weights," Charlton told Racing NSW. "We felt coming off the Doncaster that the Stradbroke was a realistic aim for him. I feel like his autumn preparation was better than it looked." Charlton pointed to the strength of the gelding's recent form, including performances behind the likes of Autumn Glow (The Autumn Sun), Joliestar

and Sheza Alibi (Saxon Warrior), and said the drop back to 1300 metres should suit. "His run in the Canterbury Stakes was big and that form worked out well," he said. "We know he can freshen up and be effective back to six and a half furlongs and this is a race he can hopefully start his Stradbroke campaign in." Zac Lloyd, who partnered Linebacker in a recent barrier trial win, retains the ride.

### Luskin Star task for Sun God

Champion trainer Chris Waller says resuming import Sun God (Fastnet Rock) is one of the horses he is most eager to see during this weekend's Scone carnival as the gelding returns in Saturday's Luskin Star Stakes. The five-year-old has won three of his 13 Australian starts, including a last-start Randwick victory over a mile in February, and Waller said the stable learned valuable lessons during his previous campaign. "Sun God, I'm looking forward to him resuming," Waller said. "Last prep, we learned that a mile sees him out. It will be interesting to see how he runs fresh, and he has drawn well." A former winner over a mile and a half in England, Sun God has since shown his best Australian form at shorter trips and will jump from barrier two in the 1300-metre feature. Waller will also saddle the consistent Captain Furai (Toronado), who has drawn barrier ten, while Waterford (Awtaad) is expected to contest Friday's Scone Cup (Listed, 1600m) rather than back up in the Luskin Star. "Captain Furai, he has a slightly tricky draw but gee, he's racing consistently," Waller said. "He needs luck from that draw, but he has trained on really well." The stable is also leaning towards the Dark Jewel Classic (Gr 3, 1400m) with Chica Mojito (Zacinto), who has accepted for both the fillies and mares' feature and the Scone Cup.

### Dark Jewel defence for Melody Again

Trainer Scott Singleton believes defending champion Melody Again (Your Song) returns

to Saturday's Dark Jewel Classic at Scone in even better form than when she caused a \$41 upset in last year's edition. No mare has won the Dark Jewel twice, but Singleton said Melody Again had continued to prove herself at stakes level despite not winning since her breakthrough success 12 months ago. "She's arguably in much better form this year than last year," Singleton said. "It was no fluke last year, she's performed well in quite a few stakes races since then." The six-year-old has been placed in both the Festival Stakes (Gr 3, 1500m) and Newcastle Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) this campaign and was also a close fourth in the Coolmore Classic (Gr 1, 1500m) before finishing down the track behind Idle Flyer (Dundeel) in the Queen Of The Turf Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m). Singleton said the brutal tempo set by Pride Of Jenni in that race had not suited his mare, who has since enjoyed a five-week freshen-up. "She's quite brilliant when she's right, she can get back and sprint home," he said. "Pride Of Jenni, that first 1000 metres of that race was run so brutally, took the finish out of a horse like mine." Melody Again surged through along the inside from last to win the Dark Jewel last year but will jump from a wide barrier this time. Singleton said the draw was not a major concern provided she secures clear running.

### Harlem Queen chasing Dark Jewel crown

The stable has enjoyed a strong run with sprinters, highlighted by Zealously's (Harry Angel) victory in the Hawkesbury Gold Rush (Listed, 1100m), while King Of Roseau (Capitalist) and Beadman (Snitzel) added interstate stakes wins last week in the Takeover Target Stakes (Listed, 1200m) at Gosford and the Gold Coast Guineas (Gr 3 1200m) respectively. "We're lucky we've got some troops back and they've all been firing," Snowden said. "It's a bit of a juggling act, but it's a good problem to have." At the Scone carnival, Snowden's team will include King Of Sparta (I Am Invincible) and Fire Star (Deep Field) in the Ortensia Stakes (Listed, 1100m), Tuileries (So You Think) in the Dark Jewel Classic, and Akaysha (Capitalist) alongside Miss Freelove (Tassort) in the Denise's Joy Stakes (Listed, 1100m). Miss Freelove has been redirected from

Brisbane to Scone after drawing favourably in barrier four and Snowden expects winkers to help the filly settle closer in running. "She went back and they weren't making ground. She did run on, but she was a bit too far back," Snowden said of her first-up effort at Warwick Farm. "I've added some headgear and hopefully that gets her more involved."

### Gilded Water impresses in Caulfield trial

She has just shown so much speed and we are very excited about her on Saturday."

### Te Akau score home juvenile quinella

Te Akau Racing continued their juvenile dominance at their home meeting at Matamata on Wednesday when taking out the quinella in the Entain/NZB Insurance Pearl Series (1200m) courtesy of Honour Roll (Savabeel) and The Queen's Sword (Sword Of State). Honour Roll was having his second start after placing on debut at Tauherenikau in February, while The Queen's Sword was making her debut after

winning her 800-metre trial at Avondale last month. Honour Roll rocketed out of the gates and was sent straight to the front by jockey Michael McNab, while The Queen's Sword was taken back to settle near the rear of the field under Masa Hashizume. Honour Roll kicked clear of his rivals at the turn and had a one length advantage at the top of the straight, which he continued to grow, eventually running out a 3.6 lengths victor over The Queen's Sword, who took the shortest way home along the rail to make up serious ground late. "We gave him a break after his first run thinking that the black-type races in July could be suitable, but now that he's won impressively on a decent track it could mean we look more towards his three-year-old season," Sam Bergerson, who trains the pair in partnership with Mark Walker, said of Honour Roll. Bergerson said The Queen's Sword would derive plenty of benefit out of Wednesday's run. "She would have learned a lot and we think she's going to be a really nice three-year-old filly," he said. "Masa [Hashizume] gave her a great ride from the draw [barrier ten] and she attacked the line late. Obviously, the winner skipped away, but she's a nice filly to look forward to next season."

# Danny Shum takes over trainers' championship lead with Happy Valley treble

**D**anny Shum has forged to the lead in an engrossing battle for the 2025/26 Hong Kong trainers' championship with a treble at Happy Valley on Wednesday night, taking over from Mark Newnham and Caspar Fownes at the top of the standings.

Shum's three-timer with Romantic Gladiator (Ten Sovereigns), General Redwood (Redwood) and Leading Agility (D'Argento) saw the accomplished horseman become the first trainer – other than Newnham or Fownes – to hold the lead in the championship since September.

Since then, Newnham and Fownes have occupied the top two spots with the lead changing hands 11 times.

With 17 meetings left in the season, Shum sits on top with 54 wins from Newnham (52), Fownes (51), David Hayes (48), Francis Lui (47) and John Size (45).

"I will try my best for the championship, but the main thing for me is the horses. I won't push them any harder just to win it, their health and happiness is the main priority for me," Shum said.

Shum struck with Romantic Gladiator in the Class 3 French May Trophy Handicap (1650m) for Zac Purton, General Redwood in the first section of the Class 4 Saint-Cloud Handicap (1650m) under Angus Chung and Leading Agility in the first section of the Class 4 Chantilly Handicap (1200m) for Lyle Hewitson.

Formerly known as Amakhala Warrior when he was unbeaten in two starts for William Knight in England, Romantic Gladiator earned a HK\$1.5 million (approx. AU\$264,270) PP Bonus after Purton gave the gelding a precision ride.

"He's done a good job as a lightly-raced three-year-old to settle in here as he has," Purton said. "Obviously he had a light weight, barrier one and a perfect run tonight, so

everything was there for him to get the victory tonight, if he could.

"But he still has to do it [win], he was a bit aggressive in the run and he's still learning – he has to relax a bit better."

Shum said: "He [Romantic Gladiator] can handle Happy Valley very well. I'm very happy with that. But he still pulls, he needs to learn to relax a little bit more. He holds his breath, so he needs to learn a little bit more to relax himself. He will be more successful next season."

General Redwood finished stoutly for Chung to post his second course and distance triumph before Leading Agility slotted his first career win with a stylish performance, while 13-time Hong Kong Champion Trainer Size also remains in the title hunt after the victory of Nebraskan (Snitzel) in the second section of the Class 4 Chantilly Handicap (1200m) under Andrea Atzeni. Winless in his first 29 Hong Kong starts with nine minor placings, Nebraskan made it two wins in a row after leading throughout.

Lui bolstered his hopes of a second trainers' championship when Packing Angel (Shocking) – third in last season's Hong Kong Derby (2000m) to Cap Ferrat (Snitzel) – returned to top form with a brilliant victory in the Class 2 ParisLongchamp Handicap (1650m) under Harry Bentley.

The gelding underwent knee surgery following the Hong Kong Derby and has slowly built form under Lui's patient approach.

Purton moved to 1,992 Hong Kong wins with a double after producing an incredible ride to pilot The Azure (Wrote) to victory in the second section of the Class 4 Saint-Cloud Handicap (1650m).

Last on the home turn, Purton waited for the gaps to open, steaming to his fourth victory

on the gelding from four rides.

"I had no choice from the gate [eight] but to go back, he travelled like a winner all the way," Purton said. "When I started to come through [the field], he started to think about it a little bit but when he found a bit more room, he knuckled down nicely."

Preparing to ride expected favourite Jimmysstar (Per Incanto) in the Doomben 10,000 (Gr 1, 1200m) in Brisbane, Australia on Saturday, Ethan Brown claimed his second Hong Kong win when David Eustace's Podium (Medaglia D'Oro) outlasted Setanta (Fastnet Rock) in the Class 5 Maisons-Laffitte Handicap (1650m).

Tony Cruz and Hugh Bowman combined with Liveandlelive (Muhaarar) to land the Class 3 France Galop Cup Handicap (1800m). A dual winner in England for William Muir and Chris Grassick, the Muhaarar (Oasis Dream) gelding controlled the race from the front to claim his second victory in Hong Kong.

Cody Mo continued an excellent season with Motor's (Fastnet Rock) success in the Class 3 Deauville Handicap (1200m) for Karis Teetan, who made full use of the inside gate to pilot the Fastnet Rock (Danehill) gelding to his third win from 14 starts.

Hong Kong racing continues at Sha Tin on Sunday.

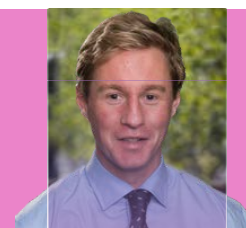
