# Doomben 10,000 the crowning glory for Rothfire and Heathcote

**T**rainer Rob Heathcote has enjoyed some of Queensland racing's greatest moments with champions such as Buffering (Mossman), but he declared Rothfire's remarkable victory in Saturday's Doomben 10,000 (Gr 1, 1200m) among the finest achievements of his career after the veteran sprinter produced an emotional hometown triumph at Doomben.

Almost six years after his first elite-level success in the JJ Atkins Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) as a

two-year-old back in 2020, Rothfire (Rothsay) returned to the Group 1 winners circle and in doing so, became the oldest horse to win the Doomben 10,000 since it was first run in 1933 and the first Australian horse in over two decades to claim Group 1 victories at both two and eight years of age.

"To all the Queenslanders out there who had faith in Rothie, this is for you," an emotional Heathcote said in the enclosure after Brad Rawiller returned to scale on the \$5.76 million earner. "This is the culmination of my career and it's his crowning glory." **Continued on page 3**

### Queen Regent shocks Scone as Miss Freelove lands breakthrough win

A pair of breakthrough stakes winners provided two of the headline performances at Scone on Saturday, with Queen Regent (Wild Ruler) causing one of the biggest upsets of the carnival before Miss Freelove (Tassort) captured a deserved black type win later in the afternoon.

The \$200,000 Woodlands Stakes (Listed, 1100m) produced a stunning boilover when the regally named Queen Regent surged home to score at odds of \$151, handing Blake Ryan his maiden stakes victory as a trainer at her second start. **Continued on page 5**

**Continued from page 2** Rothfire was faced with a new generation of headline sprinters including race favourite Jimmysstar (Per Incanto), along with heavily-backed colts Napoleonic (Wootton Bassett) and Grafterburners (Graff), both viewed as emerging stallion prospects.

The field also featured exciting three-year-old Beadman (Snitzel), Group 1 winner Private Harry (Harry Angel), multiple stakes winners Skybird (Exosphere) and Uncommon James (Cable Bay), as well as last-start stakes winner Spicy Martini (Justify).

Drawn awkwardly in barrier 15, Brad Rawiller allowed the gelding to settle deep throughout before gradually building momentum approaching the home turn and was perfectly placed to challenge front-runner Zarastro (I Am Invincible), producing a turn of foot that a horse half his age would have been proud of in the straight.

Rothfire surged clear late from the in-form mare Spicy Martini, with Napoleonic finishing third as the veteran gelding received a Group 1 ovation from the Doomben crowd.

"He's been an absolute trooper for Queensland," Heathcote continued. "We've dealt with several severe injuries along the way but he always comes back.

"This my first Group 1 since Startantes won the Tatt's Tiara in 2022. I was also here on Black Caviar Day and that was amazing but for Rothfire to do what he has done today means the world to me."

Rothfire's cult status in Queensland has only strengthened with time. After the gelding captured the 2024 King Of The Mountain

(1200m) at Toowoomba carrying 60 kilos from a wide gate, Heathcote revealed stable staff affectionately place a crown on his box at home and call him "The King".

"It's a miracle this horse is still racing," Heathcote said at the time.

Rothfire may not have been considered in the betting off the back of his tenth placing at Rockhampton in early May, but Heathcote revealed Rothfire's disappointing effort in The Archer (1300m) may not have been as poor as it appeared on paper and instead helped to tighten the gelding perfectly for the Group 1 feature.

A natural from the outset, Rothfire exploded onto the scene as a juvenile during the 2020 Brisbane Winter Carnival, winning the Champagne Classic (Gr 2, 1200m) by more than a length over Isotope (Deep Field) and then producing a dominant display when winning the J J Atkins by more than three lengths.

He then travelled south as a spring three-year-old and immediately measured up against the best of his generation in Sydney, defeating Ole Kirk (Written Tycoon) in the Run To The Rose (Gr 2, 1200m) at Rosehill.

Two weeks later he again clashed with Ole Kirk when fourth in the Golden Rose (Gr 1, 1400m), the contest in which he broke down so badly it was feared he may never race again. Fellow future stallions North Pacific (Brazen Beau) and King's Legacy (Redoute's Choice) filled the placings that day.

Rothfire made several successful raids south, capturing the Ian McEwen Stakes (Gr 2, 1000m) at Moonee Valley and the Sydney Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) at Randwick, adding further riches to a syndicate managed by Heathcote's

wife Vicki. He has gone close to further Group 1 success previously, finishing second to Sunshine In Paris (Invader) in last year's Doomben 10,000, in addition to runner-up finishes in the 2023 Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1400m) and 2022 Manikato Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m).

Brad Rawiller was riding the eight-year-old for the first time in the Doomben 10,000 and sought advice from his brother Nash, who piloted Rothfire to win the 2023 Victory Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m).

"That made it so much better when Nash was there to greet me when I came back in," Brad said.

"I was happy coming into the race. I know you could make a case for him being past his best but I thought I had a genuine chance even though he was one of the outsiders. I couldn't believe how good he looked, so full credit to Rob and his team.

"I didn't want to get into a speed battle because that would have been game over. I sat three and four wide because it was better ground out there. He was picking up before the turn and, with older horses, you just need to give them that little bit of confidence.

"I knew the trainer had done his job and I knew the horse would keep giving because he's a fighter. That made me think we might be on here today."

Despite multiple injury setbacks throughout his career, Rothfire has remained a consistent force at the elite level and, remarkably, the story may not yet be over.

"We might even have another crack at the Kingsford Smith," Heathcote said.

## Queen Regent shocks Scone as Miss Freelove lands breakthrough win

A pair of breakthrough stakes winners provided two of the headline performances at Scone on Saturday, with Queen Regent (Wild Ruler) causing one of the biggest upsets of the carnival before Miss Freelove (Tassort) captured a deserved black type win later in the afternoon.

The \$200,000 Woodlands Stakes (Listed, 1100m) produced a stunning boilover when the regally named Queen Regent surged home to score at odds of \$151, handing Blake Ryan his maiden stakes victory as a trainer at her second start.

Ridden patiently by Jay Ford, the daughter of Wild Ruler (Snitzel) settled with cover before unleashing a powerful late sprint to defeat Found The Gold (Too Darn Hot) by 1.6 lengths, with \$1.8 million yearling Lady Catalina (Written Tycoon) third. Hot favourite and \$1.6 million purchase Moscatel (Snitzel) finished sixth.

The result capped a remarkable rise for the filly, who Ryan purchased for just \$40,000 from the HTBA Yearling Sale before failing to attract support from buyers or investors. She later failed to meet a \$30,000 reserve at the Ready To Run Sale before breeder Geoff Wilson elected to rejoin the ownership group.

"We got it all wrong on debut at Hawkesbury [last month]," Ryan said. "She went too hard, but she's always shown us good ability.

"I told Jay whatever you do just find cover. She switched off beautifully and that gave her the chance to show her acceleration."

Ford said the filly benefited from being ridden more conservatively after overdoing things on debut.

"She has shown us so much at home," Ford said. "Being held up for part of the straight probably worked in her favour because once she got clear, she really let down."

Queen Regent's dam Miss Vixen (Foxwedge) won at Caulfield and Sandown for trainer Cindy Alderson and her mother Lynn, who've already enjoyed a season to remember with born-again sprinter Jigsaw (Manhattan Rain).

The filly became the second stakes winner for first-season Newgate Farm sire Wild Ruler, following on from Silver Slipper Stakes (Gr 2, 1100m) winner Stretan Ruler. He stands for a fee of \$27,500 (inc GST).

Later in the day, fellow Newgate Farm sire

Tassort (Brazen Beau) chalked up his fourth individual stakes winner when Peter Snowden-trained filly Miss Freelove claimed a deserved breakthrough in the Denise's Joy Stakes (Listed, 1100m).

The three-year-old, placed at Group 3 level during the spring and winner of the Magic Millions Sunlight Consolation 3YO Plate (1100m) in January, produced a strong finish on the rail under Rachel King to edge out Mercy Me (Hellbent) by a head. Shady Road (Written Tycoon) was a head further away in third.

It was King's third Denise's Joy Stakes win after her earlier successes on Zapateo (Brazen Beau) in 2022 and Fituese (Deep Field) in 2020. King, riding the filly for the first time, credited the addition of blinkers with helping her settle closer in running. **Continued on page 6**

Continued from page 5 “She was able to travel well through the race and stay in contention,” King said. “She’s got a really good turn of foot and she really attacked the line.”

Stable representative Aaron Lau confirmed the filly was likely to continue on to the Brisbane winter carnival following her maiden stakes success.

“She deserves to be added to Peter’s team for Brisbane,” Lau said. “She was excellent today. We always knew she would run a strong 1100 metres.

“We added the winkers because she has been getting a little too far back in her races and she enjoyed a good run. Rachel gave her a great ride and the filly was really game under pressure.”

Bred by Redback North’s Middleton family, Miss Freelove was purchased for \$110,000 by Trilogy Racing and Suman Hedge Bloodstock from Twin Hills Stud at the Magic Millions Adelaide Yearling Sale. She is out of Vee (Sebring) – an unraced half-sister to Perth Stakes (Listed, 1100m) winner Terror Force (Al

Maher) – and has now won four of her ten starts and earned over \$400,000.

The carnival concluded on a sombre note with news that hobby trainer Stephen Meyer had died following injuries sustained in an incident at Friday’s opening day meeting.

The 71-year-old Tamworth horseman was kicked by a horse in the mounting yard area prior to the final race on

Friday, in which his galloper Danza In The Dark (Summa Cum Laude) competed. Meyer, who trained on a small scale for almost two decades, was best known for campaigning Danza In The Dark to victories in last year’s Walcha Cup

(1440m) and Quirindi Cup (1600m).

In a statement, Racing NSW chief executive Peter V’landys described Meyer as a respected horseman admired for his integrity, humility and passion for racing.

#### First for Captivant

VINERY STUD

Unbeaten juvenile Vantorix (2 g ex Miss Loren, by Stryker) provided Vinery Stud sire Captivant (Capitalist) with his first individual stakes winner after a tense victory in the Spirit Of Boom Classic (Gr 2, 1200m) at Doomben on Saturday. Vantorix skipped clear for James McDonald at the furlong but was all out when Martist (Trapeze Artist), Dream Roca (El Roca) and Boomtowns (Written Tycoon) closed late for a four-way finish. The Jenny Graham-trained gelding prevailed by 0.4 lengths. "I was very nervous near the line," Graham admitted. "Now I can't wipe the smile from my face. He's exciting and James was excellent. We know he has ability but today was a step up in grade. A lot of the owners are old friends and clients so I'm as happy as." Graham confirmed his winter targets are the BRC Sires' Produce Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) at Eagle Farm on May 30 and J.J. Atkins

Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) at Eagle Farm June 13. A half-brother to San Domenico Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) winner Raging Force (Cosmic Force), Vantorix was bred by Hunter Valley vet Dr Richard McClenahan from Miss Loren (Stryker) who was placed in the 2014 MRC Debutante Stakes (Listed, 1000m) at Caulfield. Vantorix was a \$30,000 buy for his trainer at the Inglis Classic Yearling Sale. ATC Champagne Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Captivant will cover his fifth book of mares at an \$11,000 (inc GST) fee.

#### Ten for Super Seth

Coolmore sire Super Seth (Dundeel) recorded his tenth individual stakes winner when Kilman (3 g ex Thy by O'Reilly) led throughout to land Saturday's Rough Habit Plate (Gr 3 2000m) at Doomben. Kilman had not won since his debut success at Warwick Farm in March last year but had produced encouraging recent efforts when second in the Carbine Club Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m) and fourth in the Queensland Guineas (Gr 2, 1600m). Drawn the outside gate in Saturday's field of 16, Ryan Maloney pressed forward early before allowing Kilman to dictate terms in front. The gelding kicked strongly turning for home and held off the challengers late to score by 1.2 lengths over Beauty Swift (Pierro) and third placed Providence (Wooton Bassett). Prepared by champion trainer Chris Waller, Kilman gave the stable a fourth

consecutive victory in the Queensland Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) lead-up race. "He's made a lot of physical progression," Waller said. "He ran well in the Carbine Club and Queensland Guineas, and he was excellent again today under a very good ride by Ryan." Maloney said Kilman relaxed beautifully in running and gave every indication he would appreciate stepping up to 2400 metres in the Queensland Derby. Bred by Waikato Stud, Kilman was purchased by Waller Racing and Mulcaster Bloodstock for \$360,000 from the 2024 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale. He is out of Listed winner Thy (O'Reilly), a three-quarter sister to New Zealand Champion Three-Year-Old The Jewel (O'Reilly) and half-sister to New Zealand 1,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) winner La Bella Diosa (So You Think). Super Seth will stand the upcoming season at a fee of \$137,500 (inc GST).

#### Middle Earth lands first Australian stakes win

Imported galloper Middle Earth (Roaring Lion) added a first Australian black-type victory to his record when taking out Saturday's Chairman's Handicap (Gr 3, 2000m) at Doomben for trainer Ciaran Maher. Previously a stakes winner overseas and third in last year's Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m), the six-year-old produced a strong finishing effort under Ethan Brown to score by a length from Belvedere Boys

(Maurice) with stablemate Royal Supremacy (Make Believe) a further 0.6 lengths away in third. "He was very strong through the line last time and I thought the step up in distance today would suit," Maher said. "It was a pretty cool ride by Brownie, I thought we were in a fair bit of trouble coming to the turn, but he got a skinny run up the rail so it was a brave ride. The horse ran a great race in the Melbourne Cup last year, so it's good to see him come back well and I'm really pleased for Qatar Racing and all his connections. We'll head towards the Q22 with him now." Maher said the stable had deliberately targeted the Brisbane Winter Carnival after giving the gelding a lengthy break following the spring. Brown, who flew back from Hong Kong for three rides at the meeting, said Middle Earth continues to improve with racing and maturity. "He's been a good horse to me, obviously we ran third in the Melbourne Cup last year and he seems to be getting better with age," Brown said. "These imports tend to take time to produce their best, and I think the application of winkers helped today because they sharpened him up a bit. The further he goes the better he'll get, so I think he's in for a good prep."

### 41 for Pierro

War Eternal (7 g ex Aleria, by Fastnet Rock) became the 41st stakes winner for Coolmore sire Pierro (Lonhro) when he broke through for a deserved feature-race success in Saturday's \$200,000 Bernborough Handicap (Listed, 1600m) at Doomben. Prepared by Bjorn Baker, the seven-year-old had previously been placed three times at black-type level and finished fourth in the Randwick Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) during his three-year-old season. He also entered Saturday's contest off a strong third in the Hawkesbury Cup (Gr 3, 1600m) earlier this month. Ridden by Hong Kong-based jockey Zac Purton, War Eternal enjoyed a perfect run from the inside barrier before driving

### Zakouma gains Cup berth with Andrew Ramsden success

**C**ranbourne trainer Grahame Begg can start planning a path towards this year's Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) with Saturday's Andrew Ramsden Stakes (Listed, 2800m) winner Zakouma (Crowded House) after the gelding came from the clouds to land the Listed event, which carries a prized ballot exemption from Flemington's \$10 million showpiece.

A five-year-old son of Crowded House (Rainbow Quest), Zakouma took his record to five wins from 14 starts with his resolute 0.8-length victory.

The gelding, who started \$5, was a long way back when the tempo ramped up from the 1000 metres but wound up late to wear down the gutsy Pounding (Exceed And Excel) and \$71 outsider Chartwell House (Churchill), who was a half-length away in third after appearing set for a surprise win early in the straight.

"This horse is a true stayer," Begg said. "He's a horse I can run first-up in an 1800-metre race or something like that, so that we get him here [to Flemington] fit and well on the first Tuesday in November."

Winning jockey Jordan Childs endorsed Zakouma as a horse who will not be out of place at Flemington on Melbourne Cup Day.

"The way he got through the line today, he definitely gives me enough of a feel that he should be able to stay in the distance," Childs said.

"He's got that entry now so Grahame can plot a path and hopefully he's there on the first Tuesday in November. And I might have

to start dieting now."

Owner-breeders Trevor and Terrie Delroy have been very patient with Zakouma but know the drill after dealing successfully with his family, going back three generations to British-bred mare Shana (Darshaan).

The Delroys own Wyadup Valley Farm near Yallingup on WA's south-west coast and have bred and/or owned Group 1 Classic winners Helenus (Helissio), Ethiopia (Helenus), Gondokoro (Zabeel) and Zabeelionaire (Zabeel).

Zakouma's dam Dar Es Salaam (Zabeel) is a younger full-sister to Gondokoro and Zabeelionaire. Second-dam Kisumu (Carnegie) won a Sale maiden and earned Group 2 black-type when runner-up to Miss Finland (Redoute's Choice) in the 2007 Angus Armanasco Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m).

Kisumu was one of four winners from third-dam Shana and her residual value improved by multiples after her first foal happened to be Zabeelionaire. Shaana was bred in Newmarket by prolific and respected breeder Kirsten Rausing.

through along the rail in the straight to defeat Our Queen (Night Of Thunder) by 0.7 lengths. “He’s been a remarkable horse for the stable,” Baker’s representative Jim Clarke said. “It’s a well-deserved first stakes win because he’s hit the crossbar a few times now.” War Eternal has now won six of his 38 starts and lifted his earnings to almost \$1 million. Bred by Cambridge Stud principals Brendan and Jo Lindsay, War Eternal was purchased by Baker for \$160,000 from Karaka Book 1 in 2020. He is the first foal out of the Fastnet Rock (Danehill) mare Aleria, whose subsequent progeny include the multiple-winning Undaunting (Almanzor) and Ready To Run Sale graduate Stoneflight (Per Incanto), who sold for \$750,000 at Karaka last year. Pierro will stand the 2026 season at \$22,000 (inc GST).

### 35 for Churchill

Cigar Flick (5 m ex Palmateer by Fastnet Rock) provided former Coolmore shuttler Churchill (Galileo) with a 35th individual stakes winner when she added Saturday’s Magic Millions Bright Shadow Quality (Listed, 1110m) at Doomben to her consistent record. Prepared by champion trainer Chris Waller, the five-year-old resumed off two lead-up trials and relished the Soft 7 conditions, with Tommy Berry producing a patient ride before driving the mare through along the inside to score by 1.2 lengths over Zouperb (Zoustar). “She’s definitely better on soft tracks. She also runs well fresh and Tommy knows her well too,” Waller said. “The plan was to be conservative with her for the first half of the race and save her up for one last crack at them.” Berry, who has now partnered Cigar Flick in three of her six victories, said confidence was high after her recent trial performances. “I rode her with a bit of confidence knowing that she’s got a lethal turn of foot, especially on this ground,” he said. “It’s always a privilege to ride a winner in these famous colours.” Carrying the famous cerise

silks of the Ingham Racing family, Cigar Flick has now won six of her 31 starts and pushed her earnings beyond \$700,000. The homebred mare is the best of two winners out of Palmateer (Fastnet Rock), a metropolitan-winning half-sister to four-time Group 1 winner Fangirl (Sebring). Churchill stood seven seasons shuttling to Coolmore Stud before remaining on the Irish roster at a fee of €15,000 (approx. AU\$24,378).

### 34 for All Too Hard

Vinery Stud sire All Too Hard (Casino Prince) added a 34th individual stakes winner to his CV on Saturday when Losesomewinmore (6 g ex Raischek, by Mossman) took out the Straight Six Handicap (Listed, 1200m) at Flemington. Prepared by South Australian trainers Richard Jolly and Chantelle Jolly, the gelding continued his outstanding affinity with Flemington’s straight track, where five of his seven career wins have now been recorded. Ridden quietly near the tail by Jett Stanley, Losesomewinmore unleashed a sharp sprint down the outside to sweep past his rivals and score by two lengths over De Bergerac (Zoustar), with Hearcomesthestar (Zoustar) third. “His straight form is probably exceptional and he’s really brought it to the fore today,” Richard Jolly said. “He’s a horse that likes a bit of cover early. Just ride him quiet and he’s got a good, short, sharp sprint.” The victory was Losesomewinmore’s third from his past four starts and lifted his earnings beyond \$440,000 from 14 career appearances. Purchased by Simple Bloodstock Services for \$80,000 from the Vinery Stud draft at the Inglis Premier Yearling Sale, Losesomewinmore was bred by Echo Beach Bloodstock. He is the third winner from five runners out of the Mossman (Success Express) mare Raischek, a sister to Group 3 winner Stirling Grove from the family of Group 1 winner Hucklebuck (Elvstroem) and Group 1-placed mare She’s Bulletproof (Shooting To Win). All Too Hard will stand for a fee of \$27,500 (inc GST) in 2026.

### Concord Connie keeps rising with another Flemington win

Contributer (High Chaparral) filly Concord Connie continued her rise through the grades with another impressive Flemington victory on Saturday, further enhancing her reputation as one of Victoria’s most promising three-year-old fillies. Prepared by Charlotte Littlefield, Concord Connie followed her dominant six-length Anzac Day victory at HQ with a stylish win in the \$150,000 K A Morrison Handicap (1400m). The heavily backed \$1.35 favourite settled comfortably before surging clear under Jett Stanley to defeat Flying Done (Kermadec) by 1.3 lengths, despite Stanley dropping his whip midway down the straight. “Obviously she wasn’t quite as dominant today, but now we find out why,” Littlefield said. “She’s a horse that wants to be a racehorse, I think she enjoys that challenge.” Stanley later revealed the whip became entangled in the filly’s mane approaching the 300-metre mark, although he joked post-race that avoiding another suspension may not have been the worst outcome. “She’s probably come to the end of her preparation and she was probably looking for the mile today too,” Stanley said. “But I feel next preparation you’ll see a bigger, stronger and more robust horse.” The victory was the 200th of Stanley’s riding career and further strengthened Concord Connie’s spring credentials, with Littlefield indicating the Empire Rose Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) at Flemington could become a long-range target later in the year.

Newgate Farm first-season sire Wild Ruler (Snitzel) welcomed his second individual stakes winner on Saturday when \$151 outsider Queen Regent (2 f ex Miss Vixen, by Foxwedge) upset her odds in Saturday's Woodlands Stakes (Listed, 1100m) at Scone. Queen Regent is the first stakes winner out of the Group 3-placed Foxwedge (Fastnet Rock) mare Miss Vixen, a half-sister to the Group 3-placed Veranskova (Written Tycoon). Purchased by Ryan for \$40,000 from the HTBA Yearling Sale, the filly was later passed in for \$30,000 at the NZB Ready To Run Sale. Wild Ruler (Snitzel), whose daughter Pinkish Hue also won on debut at Toowoomba earlier in the day, will stand this spring at Newgate at a fee of \$27,500 (inc GST).

### Four for Tassort

Miss Freelove (3 f ex Vee, by Sebring) became the fourth stakes winner for Newgate Farm's Tassort (Brazen Beau) when producing a smart finishing burst to win Saturday's Denise's Joy Stakes (Listed, 1100m) at Scone. A \$110,000 purchase for Trilogy Racing from Twin Hills at the 2024 Magic Millions Adelaide Yearling Sale, Miss Freelove has now won four races from 10 starts and continues to build a valuable black-type record for her connections. Bred by the Middleton family's Redbank North operation, she is one of three winners from the unraced Sebring (More Than Ready) mare Vee, a half-sister to Perth Stakes (Listed, 1100m) winner Terror Force (Al Maher). Tassort will stand this spring at Newgate at a fee of \$33,000 (inc GST).

### 24 for Shalaa

Bev's Nine (4 g ex Emancipationist, by Elusive Quality) became the 24th individual stakes winner for Arrowfield Stud's Shalaa (Invincible Spirit) when landing Saturday's Ortensia Stakes (Listed, 1100m) at Scone. Trained by Tom Charlton and formerly at the centre of a controversial Racing NSW veterinary ruling earlier this year, the lightly raced gelding returned the focus to the track with a determined black-type breakthrough under Zac Lloyd. Jumping sharply to take up a prominent position, Bev's Nine controlled the race throughout before fighting strongly to hold off fast-finishing Brudenell (Russian Revolution) by a short half head, with Golden Straand (Snitzel) another length away in third. Lloyd, who has ridden the gelding extensively in trackwork, said his toughness had again come to the fore. "He is just very tough. He's all heart," Lloyd said. "That horse came to him, but he kept fighting." The victory improved Bev's Nine's record to six wins from just eight starts and lifted his earnings beyond \$340,000. Initially passed in at the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale Book 2, the gelding later sold online for just \$25,000 before developing into a stakes winner for his connections. Shalaa will stand this spring at Woodside Park Stud at a fee of \$13,200 (inc GST).

### 200 for Fastnet Rock

Sun God (5 g ex Seaduced, by Lope De Vega) became the landmark 200th stakes winner for the late champion sire Fastnet Rock (Danahill) when taking out Saturday's Luskin Star Stakes (Listed, 1300m) at Scone. Prepared by Chris Waller, the imported gelding settled off the speed under Tyler Schiller before finishing strongly to defeat Point And Shoot (Blue Point) by 0.2 lengths, with Bosustow (Blue Point) another 1.1 lengths away in third. A winner of the Old Rowley Cup (1m 4f) at Newmarket before joining the Waller stable, Sun God has now won six races and more than \$540,000 in prize money from 25 starts across Britain and Australia. Bred

in Britain by Deerfield Farm, Sun God is one of three winners from the unraced Lope De Vega (Shamardal) mare Seaduced, herself a half-sister to Group 2 winners Stay Alert (Fastnet Rock) and Star Rock (Fastnet Rock). The family is steeped in black type, including Group 2 winning half-sister to Sun God, Sumo Sam (Nathaniel).

### Tuileries scores record-breaking win in the Dark Jewel Classic

So You Think (High Chaparral) mare Tuileries produced a career-best performance to overcome a wide barrier and topweight in Saturday's Dark Jewel Classic (Gr 3, 1400m) at Scone, handing trainer Peter Snowden a record fourth victory in the race. Carrying 59.5kg, Tuileries broke the race's longstanding weight-carrying record previously held by Nanny Maroon (Alquoz), who won with 58.5kg in 2001. Drawn barrier 15, Chad Schofield allowed the lightly raced four-year-old to stride forward early before slotting into cover, with the mare relaxing notably well after previously showing a tendency to over-race. Surfin' Bird (The Autumn Sun) travelled strongly into the race approaching the 300 metres, but Tuileries quickly swept around the field with a powerful finishing burst to score by 0.8 lengths over Luvnwar (War Decree), with Yes Lulu (Yes Yes Yes) another 0.4 lengths away in third. "That was a special win," Schofield said. "I had drawn so wide that I wasn't sure where I was going to get to early, but she flew out of the barriers and then I reverse parked into the first position I could. She has turned the corner and developed into a lovely mare. When she relaxes like that she has a breathtaking turn of foot." Schofield said the performance suggested Tuileries could measure up in stronger company through the Brisbane Winter Carnival. "The feel she gave me there with a big weight is one of a very good mare," he said. The victory capped a successful afternoon for the Snowden stable after Miss Freelove captured the Denise's Joy Stakes earlier on the program.

### Autumn King earns Queensland shot

Autumn King (The Autumn Sun) continued his progressive campaign with a determined victory in Saturday's Highway Handicap (1600m) at Scone, prompting connections to set their sights on the Winx Guineas (Gr 3, 1600m) during the Queensland Winter Carnival. The Paul Messara and Leah Gavranich-trained colt had been competitive in stakes company at his previous two starts, finishing fifth in both the South Pacific Classic (Listed, 1400m) at Randwick and the Queensland Guineas (Gr 2, 1600m) at Eagle Farm. Dropping back in grade at Scone, Autumn King overcame 61 kilos and chased down Moon Sweeper (Puissance De Lune) in the closing stages to record his third win from seven starts. Messara confirmed the Sunshine Coast's Winx Guineas on July 4 had long been the target for the colt. "Absolutely. That has been the long-term plan for him this prep," Messara told Sky Racing. "I like the way he hit the line. He is still learning his craft, the horse. He's improving all the time." Jockey Aaron Bullock, who completed an early double on the program, said Autumn King was still putting everything together mentally despite his obvious talent. "He's blessed with ability. He's just still working his craft out," Bullock said. "There was a lot more merit in that win than it looks." A \$280,000 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale purchase from Arrowfield Stud by Paul O'Brien and raced in an Arrowfield Partnership, Autumn King has now earned more than \$140,000 in prize money for connections.

### Vale Stephen Meyer

The NSW Racing community is mourning the loss of respected Tamworth Based trainer Stephen Meyer, who died following a tragic incident at Friday's Scone Cup meeting. Meyer, 71, was reportedly kicked by a horse during the opening day of the two-day Scone carnival and later passed away from his

injuries. His stable galloper Danza In The Dark (Summa Cum Laude), the only horse he trained, competed later in the final race on the program. Racing NSW paid tribute to Meyer on Saturday, describing him as a "dedicated and highly regarded horseman" known throughout the Hunter and North West region for his integrity, humility and lifelong passion for thoroughbreds. Operating as a hobby trainer from Tamworth, Meyer enjoyed notable success with Danza In The Dark, who provided him with all six of his career training victories, including the 2024 Walcha Cup (1440m) and Quirindi Cup (1600m). A minute's silence was observed before racing at Scone on Saturday as the industry honoured the popular horseman.

### New Zealand

#### 37 for Per Incanto

Incandescent (2 g ex Saint Katarina, by Snitzel) became the 37th stakes winner for Little Avondale Stud's Per Incanto (Street Cry) when taking out Saturday's Champagne Stakes (Listed, 1600m) at Ellerslie. Prepared by Roger James and Robert Wellwood for MyRacehorse and Ridgeport Holdings, the gelding settled perfectly for Joe Doyle before proving too strong late for Grocer's Girl (Tarzino), scoring by a head, with Bella Bonita (Noverre) finishing one and a half lengths away in third. The victory capped a consistent juvenile campaign for Incandescent, who had also finished runner-up in the Waikato Equine Veterinary Centre Stakes (Listed, 1400m) earlier this month. Purchased for \$200,000 from Little Avondale Stud's draft at Karaka Book 1, Incandescent is the first foal from the Snitzel (Redoute's Choice) mare Saint Katarina, a daughter of dual stakes winner St Katherine (Barathea) and from the family of Group 1 winner Bonanova (Star Way). Per Incanto, sire of Group 1 winners Roch 'N' Horse and Jimmysstar, will stand this spring at Little Avondale Stud at a fee of \$75,000 (plus GST).

### Winning form returns for Yaldi

The addition of visor blinkers for the first time appeared to sharpen the son of Ardrossan (Redoute's Choice), who was recording his first win since claiming the Auckland Guineas (Gr 2, 1400m) as a three-year-old. "It feels like a fair while, so it is great to get the job done," Forsman said. "It was a great ride by Matt as he is not an easy ride as you have to have everything go right for you. There was a little bit of a gear change with the visor blinkers on for the first time but whether that made a big difference I'm not sure as he is a quirky horse." Cartwright admitted the gelding still had plenty to learn despite his obvious talent. "This horse has got more tricks than a magician to be fair," Cartwright said. "I do hope he takes a lot of confidence from this as he has good ability and if he decides to work it all out, he is definitely black type material."

## UK: Notable Speech lands fifth top-flight victory in Lockinge Stakes

Notable Speech (Dubawi) returned to his brilliant best when providing Charlie Appleby and Godolphin with a timely Group 1 success in Saturday's Lockinge Stakes (Gr 1, 1m) at Newbury. The reigning Breeders' Cup Mile (Gr 1, 8f) winner had failed to fire on his American return in a Grade 1 at Keeneland last month, but bounced back emphatically under William Buick, who produced the son of Dubawi (Dubai Millennium) with a decisive late burst to defeat More Thunder (Night Of Thunder) and Zeus Olympios (Night Of Thunder). Sent out the well-supported 2-1 favourite, Notable Speech travelled strongly throughout before showcasing his trademark acceleration to settle the contest in the closing stages. The victory provided

Appleby with a second Lockinge and continued a resurgence for the stable following a quieter-than-usual start to the European turf season. "Today we saw the real Notable Speech," Appleby said. "He's got some turn of foot and there aren't too many horses who can quicken like he can." Bookmakers reacted swiftly to the performance, with Paddy Power trimming Notable Speech into 6-4 favourite for next month's Queen Anne Stakes (Gr 1, 1m) at Royal Ascot.

## UK: Group 1-winning mare makes successful return

Juddmonte homebred Kalpana (5 m Study Of Man - Zero Gravity, by Dansili) made a successful return to racing when taking out Saturday's Aston Park Stakes (Gr 3, 1m 4f) at Newbury. Trained by Andrew Balding and ridden by Colin Keane, the dual Group 1 winner settled off the pace before asserting two furlongs from home and holding off the late challenge of West Wind Blows (Teofilo) by a neck. There were a further 11 lengths going back to Arabian Force (Lope De Vega) in third. The victory was Kalpana's first start since her triumph in the British Champions Fillies & Mares Stakes (Gr 1, 1m 4f) at Ascot last October and provided Balding with confidence for another major campaign with the Study Of Man (Deep Impact) mare, with the main aim being a defense of that crown on Champions Day in October. "I think the Fillies & Mares will be the big plan," Balding said. "We tried the Arc last year, and it didn't work out, but I don't think any horse has won three consecutive races on Champions Day, so that would be a nice target." Balding indicated Royal Ascot would likely be

her next target, with both the Prince Of Wales's Stakes (Gr 1, 1m 2f) and Hardwicke Stakes (Gr 2, 1m 4f) under consideration.

## Seven for Starman

Second-season sire Starman (Dutch Art) recorded his seventh individual stakes winner when his filly Esna (3 f ex Dubai, by Galileo) picked up her first black-type victory in Saturday's Childwickbury Stud Fillies' Trial Stakes (Listed, 1m 2f) at Newbury. Trained by Brian Meehan and ridden by Ryan Moore, the progressive filly settled prominently before regaining the lead inside the final furlong to defeat Sacred Ground (Kingman) by half a length, with Lady Roisia (St Mark's Basilica) over three lengths away in third. Esna has now won two of her five starts after also finishing fourth in last year's Fillies' Mile (Gr 1, 1m) and the Pretty Polly Stakes (Listed, 1m 2f) earlier this month. Meehan, who also won the race in 2003, believes the progressive filly has plenty more to offer. "Esna is a big filly with lots of scope, so I think the world's her oyster," Meehan said. "She looks very progressive. "We'll talk to Ryan and see what he recommends, but my impression would be that she would get a little further." Purchased for £50,000 at the 2024 Goffs UK Premier Yearling Sale by Sam Sangster Bloodstock, Esna is out of the Galileo (Sadler's Wells) mare Dubai, whose daughter Alakhana (Dalakhani) produced ParisLongchamp Prix Dollar (Gr 2, 1950m) winner Jayarebe (Zoffany). Starman's first crop has already produced Group 1 winner Venetian Sun along with fellow stakes winners Green Sense, Lady Iman and North Coast. Starman stands at Tally-Ho Stud in Ireland at a fee of €40,000 (approx. AU\$67,000).

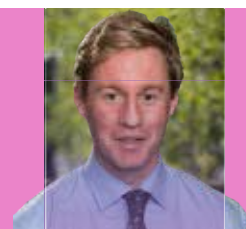
