# Emotions run high as Legarto lands at Yulong

A first date with Devil Night (Extreme Choice) awaits Legarto (Proisir) after the champion New Zealand mare was purchased by Yulong Stud for \$2.8 million in an emotion-charged sale for her ownership group on the opening day of the Magic Millions Gold Coast National Broodmare Sale.

Bidding under his Devil Night Syndicate banner, Yulong principal Yuesheng Zhang eventually emerged victorious from a spirited

battle in the ring and online to secure the services of the five-time Group 1 victor, who will soon make the journey south from the Gold Coast to the operation's new base in the Hunter Valley.

For Legarto's ownership group, who held their collective breath in the auditorium as the theatre played out, the momentous occasion was undoubtedly tinged with a degree of sadness given the unbreakable bond they had forged with the daughter of Rich Hill Stud's flagbearer Proisir (Choisir).

**Continued from page 2** Philip Brown, who sourced Legarto for the princely sum of NZ\$90,000 at the 2021 New Zealand Bloodstock National Yearling Sale, expressed relief shortly after Yulong's successful bid was lodged at \$300,000 over the \$2.5 million reserve price.

"It's been such a big build-up so there's a

sense of relief that it's over now, but there's also a little bit of sadness," he told ANZ News.

"I always knew we would have mixed emotions about selling her, and that's certainly the case. But [wife] Catherine and I have other partners in the ownership group and we came to a decision to sell, so I knew we had to put her through the ring. I'm very happy with the price and I'm thrilled that she's going to a great farm in Yulong, so I look forward to catching up with their team soon.

"We had a conversation amongst the owners over dinner last night about how much money she might make, but when we got here

this morning I decided not to worry about it and tried to relax. We had no control over it so what will be will be, and we're delighted with the result.

Continued from page 3 is a little bit unpredictable. But \$2.8 million is a lot of money to anyone, so we're happy with that price.

"We had set the reserve price at \$2.5 million, so anything above that was a bonus. We knew there was enough interest in her to justify that sort of reserve, so we were pretty confident she would realise her true worth."

Yulong general manager Jun Zhang revealed it was a case of love at first sight with Legarto; and having been outbid by Coolmore at the Inglis Chairman's Sale for top lot Chayan (I Am Invincible), the team was perhaps doubly determined to leave the Bundall complex with a mare whose elite-level success came on both sides of the Tasman Sea.

"She was the mare of the whole sale and we loved her, we fell in love when we first saw her," said Zhang, the son-in-law of Yulong's founding father.

"Every mare is very special to us, so we can't put a price tag on any of them. I think she was the one, and so we had to get her. We're going to send her to Segenhoe. We purchased Segenhoe and we need some very elite mares to support our stallions there."


Perhaps predictably, Yulong's spending spree didn't stop there as the ambitious operation added further depth to an already bulging broodmare band with the \$1.8 million acquisition of Snitzanova (Snitzel).

The dual stakes winner amassed prize-money earnings in excess of \$1 million for the Bennett Racing syndicate, and she will now get the chance to convert racetrack precocity to success at stud after Yulong confirmed her maiden mating with Devil Night's fellow Segenhoe resident Private Harry (Harry Angel).

Snitzanova holds a nomination for the Lord Mayor's Cup (Gr 3, 1800m), so there is a chance the four-year-old will make her competitive debut in Yulong's bottle green silks at Eagle Farm on Saturday - potentially setting up an intriguing clash with her former stablemate Fawkner Park (Zoffany), who will carry Bennett Racing's distinctive black and orange checks.

If Nathan Bennett was experiencing any seller's remorse, however, it was only for a fleeting moment as the prominent syndicator reflected on a potentially life-changing result for Snitzanova's ownership group.

"I thought she was probably worth that price," he said. **Continued on page 7**

Continued from page 5 "It was nerve-wracking, once you get into the million mark you're hoping for another bid here and there and we were lucky enough to get a few. It's a huge turnaround for the owners, they paid \$200,000 for her as a yearling and then for her to go on and win over a \$1 million on the track and produce \$1.8 million in the ring is a huge result.

"I'm just stoked for all the owners involved that they've got a good payday."

Arrowfield Stud soon joined the party when they went to \$1.6 million for Stretan Angel (Harry Angel), the Yarraman Park-consigned mare whose noteworthy CV was adorned with three stakes wins and a trio of Group 1 placings for trainer Philip Stokes.

Her dam Sretan (Bernardini) has further elevated her profile in recent years, with Stretan Angel's former stablemate Stretan Ruler (Wild Ruler) joining his half-sister in the black-type club courtesy of the colt's dominant victory in this year's Silver Slipper Stakes (Gr 2, 1100m).

Given that Stretan Angel's sister fetched

\$540,000 at this year's Inglis Classic Yearling Sale, the extended family is clearly in high demand and so it was no surprise that John Messara's famed farm arrowed in on the mare as a precious commodity.

"I liked everything about her," said Messara,

who confirmed that her first suitor would be The Autumn Sun (Redoute's Choice).

"I liked the pedigree, I liked the way she looked. I had a good look at her, and I liked her performance. She was three-times Group 1 placed in the best races - the Goodwood, the Newmarket and the Lightning Stakes.

"It was a tough battle out there, the top end is very competitive. But we're lucky to

have good partners and we're lucky to have active stallions, so we're making the best of it.

"I am a big believer in The Autumn Sun, you can see what he has done already. He's got a very good strike-rate, and he can throw a champion. I compare him with Snitzel and he's ahead of Snitzel at the same age. Snitzel was a slow starter but I think **Continued on page 9**

Continued from page 7 there is much to come from The Autumn Sun.”

Other notable sales included O’ Ole (Ole Kirk), who was purchased for \$1.5 million by Northern Farm’s Katsumi Yoshida.

The daughter of Vinery Stud’s highly respected resident Ole Kirk (Written Tycoon) was returning to the scene of her most famous victory, last year’s Gold Coast Magic Millions 2YO Classic (RL, 1200m). While she was ultimately unable to embellish her racing resume with any further success, the filly’s prodigious speed and deep pedigree - her dam Vellor (Sepoy) is a proven producer and the half-sister to a stakes winner - made a compelling case for Yoshida.

“We really liked how she looks, so that came first,” said Northern Farm representative Shingo Hashimoto.

“And the way she performed in the Magic Millions 2YO [Classic] was fantastic, so we really liked her. We haven’t decided yet whether to take her back to Japan or possibly keep her in Australia, but she’ll be retired.”

The filly’s \$1.5 million purchase price was later matched by Lilac (Justify), the dual stakes-winning mare who was also knocked down to Yoshida and will be set for a date with the Northern Farm-bred superstar Equinox (Kitasan Black).

The third lot to achieve \$1.5 million was Captured By Love (Written Tycoon), who was purchased online by China’s Sheng Geng.

A winner of five Group races, including the 2024 New Zealand 1,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m), the mare was consigned by Newgate Stud on behalf of David Ellis’ Te Akau Racing, who purchased her for \$525,000 as a yearling at the 2023 Magic Millions Gold Coast Sale.

## Bowditch buoyed by strong sale results on day one

Barry Bowditch hailed an “above expectations” opening to the Magic Millions Gold Coast National Broodmare Sale, which yielded a clearance rate of 85 per cent.

After defying general expectations that the sale might be impacted by a degree of hesitancy from the buying bench, Bowditch praised

the “special atmosphere” generated by several headline lots - and none more so than Legarto.

“That was definitely a highlight for a special group of owners,” said Bowditch.

“Phil and Catherine Brown and the whole Legarto team have had an extraordinary ride with the mare. It was a real privilege for us to sell Legarto on their behalf, and it got the day off to a really fiery start. Then we saw the sale of Snitzanova deliver a huge result for her big syndicate from Bennett Racing, and it’s stories like her that make these sales really memorable.

“There were some unbelievable stories at the top end, but I thought the theatre and the robust nature of the overall market through the middle end was what really stood out for me. It

was probably above our expectations, we maybe walked in here this morning with a little bit of trepidation, but to sell 85 per cent of our offerings and average just short of \$250,000 was a really pleasing result. It was a very genuine day of trading with a great spread of buyers across the board, which is what we’re always looking for.”

Across the day over \$34 million

was traded on 137 lots sold at an average price of \$249,303, with Legarto’s top price of \$2.8 million and a median price of \$110,000.

Looking ahead to the second and final day of the auction, which will feature mares in foal, Bowditch is anticipating another robust session of trading on the Gold Coast.

“I think the opportunity of mares on offer at all levels tomorrow should result in another strong day,” he said.

“There are some mares people may have to take a bit of a risk on, but there will definitely be value to be found and there are some really nice young mares in foal to some of the country’s most respected commercial stallions.”

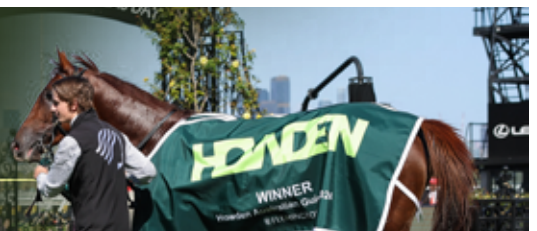

#### Third for Pinatubo

Darley shuttler Pinatubo (Shamardal) sired his third Australasian winner on Tuesday when Voynichese (2 f ex Great Mystery by Redoute's Choice) scored at the second time of asking in a maiden at Albury. Ridden by Coriah Keatings, the Nick Olive-trained filly landed the 1175-metre contest by 0.4 lengths over Hot Toddy (Prized Icon) as the odds-on favourite, going one place better than her debut second at Bathurst. There was a further 0.7 lengths back to Distant Stripes (Needs Further) in third place. Bred by Joy Mackay and John Barnes' Canning Downs Stud, Voynichese is the only foal to race from three out of the Group 3-placed winning Redoute's Choice (Danehill) mare Great Mystery. She was purchased by her trainer for \$30,000 out of Canning Downs at the 2025 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling

Sale. Pinatubo, whose Australasian progeny are headed by debut Inglis 2YO Challenge (1200m) winner Global Goal, will stand the 2026 breeding season at a fee of \$27,500 (inc GST).

#### Stable Storm on Saturday

Trainers Mick Price and Michael Kent Jnr have added a third tier to the stable's team for Saturday with news See That Storm (Storm The Stars) will kick off his first Australian campaign in a Benchmark 100 over 1600 metres at Caulfield. The Irish-bred galloper won at Redcar, Pontefract and Lingfield and was never out of a place in ten starts for UK-based trainer Ed Bethell last year. He had been purchased for 35,000gns at a Tattersalls Sale in June 2024 by Blandford Bloodstock and Bethell Racing. See That Storm now races for a syndicate managed by Tim Porter. He arrived out here last October and won a Caulfield 1400-metre barrier trial by two lengths under Craig Williams a fortnight ago. "Craig has a great association with Tim Porter through Bella Nipotina," Kent Jnr said. "He's a really cool horse and all his form has been at 2000 metres. He's a high energy, on pace galloper with a good kick and we're looking forward to this spring." Price and Kent Jnr also have Zambardo (Belardo) and Bustling (Frosted) in action on Saturday. Zambardo will be given the chance to get his winter prep back on track in the \$200,000 Lord Mayors

Cup (Listed, 2000m) at Rosehill while Bustling (Frosted) is primed to start paying back a \$2 million price-tag in the Bel Esprit Stakes (Listed, 1100m) at Caulfield.

#### Hillier Best in Classic

Zoustar (Northern Meteor) sprinter-miler Hillier has taken time to peak as a winter three-year-old but it's come just in the nick of time for the Fred Best Classic (Gr 3, 1400m) at Eagle Farm on Saturday. Hillier only had a Newcastle maiden juvenile to his credit prior to being gelded and he looked a different horse when winning a Benchmark 78 (1200m) at Gosford for trainers Annabel and Rob Archibald earlier this month. "It was a good win at Gosford and hopefully he goes on with it for OTI," Rob Archibald said. "We've always liked him and wanted to give him a chance in some of the better races over the Brisbane carnival. He was gelded after the Caulfield Guineas and had a long break with a foot issue. We see how he goes in the Fred Best but there are plenty of other nice races up here for him." Winning jockey Nash Rawiller was equally impressed on the Central Coast. "I think that bit of extra time has certainly helped," Rawiller said. "He had the form on the board and is a very promising horse." The Fred Best is a 'Win and You're In' race for the Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1400m) on June 13 and several other candidates such

### Stars align for Buthelezi

Western Australian breeder Trevor Delroy knows how to breed a Classic winner and Peter Moody knows how to train one so the stars are aligning for Buthelezi (Smart Missile) in the Queensland Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) at Eagle Farm. Buthelezi was retained by Delroy and his wife Terrie after failing to reach a \$50,000 reserve at the 2024 Perth Magic Millions Yearling Sale and he's priced at \$17 for the \$1 million Queensland Derby on Saturday. "I've only had him for the two starts," said Moody who has won the Queensland classic with Riva San (Any Given Sunday) (2008) and Brambles (Savabeel) (2012). "He ran fifth in the West Australian Guineas and won two races over there, and here he's run third in a [Benchmark] 70 at Caulfield and then ran third in open three-year-old at Flemington. When he was sent over from Perth, they wanted him for the Queensland Derby. He's coming along well and he drew wide, went back to last and then circled them. He was the winner and then he peaked last time. A different one wins these types of three-year-old races every week, so we might as well give it a go." Moody, who trains in partnership with Katherine Coleman, will also saddle up last-start The Goodwood (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Desert Lightning (Pride

Of Dubai) in the Kingsford-Smith Cup (Gr 1, 1300m) on the same card. "He's going there in good shape," Moody said. "I went to Adelaide very confident and if we can win another one, it would be a bonus. He was unlucky in the Straddie last year and he's always been around the mark. We tried him at 1800 [metres], we tried him at a mile, he just didn't see it out, so 1400 [metres] is probably his sweet spot."

### Esha goes to Gollan

Promising filly Esha (Extreme Choice) has been transferred from Mornington trainer Shane Nichols to continue her racing career with Tony Gollan in Brisbane. Esha is raced in partnership by Kia Ora Stud and Hollymount Stud after making \$900,000 at the 2024 Gold Coast Magic Millions Yearling Sale. She was bred Kingstar Farm principal Matthew Sandblom and will be one of the best-bred fillies in training at Eagle Farm. "She hasn't long arrived and we will take our time to get a feel for the filly," Gollan said. "She's shown so much promise over the past 12 months and we will plot a path into the new season." Esha was a Morphettville juvenile winner on debut last season and followed up with a front-running victory at Moonee Valley as a spring three-year-old earlier this season. She was then thrown in at the deep end of the Moir Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m) and wasn't disgraced in going down by just over two and a half lengths behind Baraquel (Snitzel). Esha is bred in the purple as a daughter of Newgate Farm supersire Extreme Choice (Not A Single Doubt) and her dam I Am A Star (I Am Invincible) won a Empire Rose Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) at Flemington in 2016.

### Kiwi Star returns to Caulfield

Former New Zealand mare Bellatrix Star (Star Witness) will make a long-awaited return to racing at Caulfield on Saturday after overcoming a series of setbacks that at one stage threatened to end her career. Bellatrix Star has battled a

string of issues over the past 18 months, most notably in January last year, when she fractured a vertebra in her neck after rearing and falling over while heading back to her stable. And just when she had fought her way back to the races, another setback followed after her run in the Doveton Stakes (Listed, 1100m) at Caulfield last November, when she was found to have chipped a fetlock and required surgery. "That fall was very unfortunate," owner John Galvin said. "She flipped over backwards and, at the time, the vet said she would never race again. But our trainer Mark Walker worked his magic and we were able to rehabilitate her. She went through a preparation with long paddock spells and a bit of dressage. When she resumed racing at Caulfield in late November, she just ran below par and the next morning we found that she had a chip in a fetlock. That was removed and it took some time after that for rehab and to get her back going again." Bellatrix Star had made a brilliant start to her career in 2024 when she won the first Australasian juvenile event of the season at Wanganui. She was no one-trick pony as evidenced when winning the Eclipse Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) at Pukekohe. Between her setbacks, Bellatrix Star won the Schillaci Stakes (Gr 2, 1100m) at Caulfield, Scarborough Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) at Moonee Valley and Cap D'Antibes Stakes (Listed, 1100m) at Flemington.

### Private Harry retired to stud

The Chris Waller-trained Private Harry (Harry Angel) has been retired from racing and will now take up stud duties at Yulong. The four-year-old Group 1 winner has produced a pair of below-par efforts this season, running eighth in the Victory Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) on his comeback before a last-start 15th in the Doomben 10,000 (Gr 1, 1200m) and the decision has been made to retire the son of Harry Angel (Dark Angel). Private Harry finishes his racing career with five wins from nine starts, and over \$2 million in prize-money. He will stand his first season at stud for a fee of \$27,500 (inc GST).

## HK: Hayes eyes championship boost as Purton closes on 2,000-win milestone

David Hayes is hoping to reignite his 2025/26 trainers' championship hopes when he saddles a six-strong team on Wednesday night at Happy Valley. The Australian Racing Hall of Famer snapped a recent frustrating spell, comprising seven seconds between his last two wins, when My Mars (Advertise) scored last Sunday. Hayes' 49 wins are seven shy of leader Danny Shum ahead of the 75th of 88 scheduled fixtures tomorrow as he searches for a third title following conquests in 1997/98 and 1998/99. Honest Witness (Written By) returns in the Class 3 Seine Handicap (1200m) for Hayes, aiming to secure a hat-trick following his last-start track and trip demolition on April 29. "He's got a good barrier [five]. He won very easily [last start]. Going up in class is always a question mark, but he got those [rating] points [plus ten] for a reason. He always had a little bit of ability, and he ran close without winning, but now he's a bit stronger and can absorb the pressure more. Hopefully, he can win three in a row," Hayes said. Honest Witness pairs with the milestone-chasing Zac Purton, who is two away from becoming the first rider to reach 2,000 winners in Hong Kong. The Australian's first victory in Hong Kong came at Happy Valley on September 12, 2007 aboard Elfhelm (Perugino). The 43-year-old leads the current

championship by 63 wins. "It's always a good sign when Zac's wasting [getting down to ride 118lb]. The horse can be a bit keen and I think part of the reason he's been able to improve so much is that we've been able to harness his enthusiasm. We'll just let him roll forward; hopefully he can dictate again and is hard to beat," Hayes said
