Miss Hellfire is hot property as curtain comes down on broodmare sale

The immense regard in which Extreme Choice (Not A Single Doubt) is held was in evidence on the final day of the Magic Millions National Broodmare Sale when his successful mating with Miss Hellfire (Hellbent) delivered a \$2.05 million payday for Newgate Stud and their partners.

A trio of lots were offered by Newgate in foal to their freakish flagbearer, and two of the three mares duly surpassed the \$1 million mark in a sure sign that the feverish demand for the progeny of Extreme Choice is showing no signs of abating.

The clear standout was Miss Hellfire, who was bred by SF Bloodstock at Newgate and returned to her birthplace when Henry Field swooped on the stakes-placed mare at last year's National Broodmare Sale. The \$640,000 Newgate paid that day for Miss Hellfire proved a masterstroke, as the triple city winner realised more than three times that figure just 12 months later.

Shortly after the winning bid was placed online from China, Yulong's Chief Operating Officer Sam Fairgray confirmed that Miss Hellfire would be joining the farm's ever-expanding broodmare band.

Bowditch hails strong metrics as sale closes

Magic Millions' managing director Barry Bowditch was "extremely satisfied" as he reflected on the auction house's two day National Broodmare Sale, which concluded with some encouraging metrics.

After 16 mares-in-foal had commanded fees of \$500,000 or more on the final day of trading on the Gold Coast, Bowditch and his team were relieved that the market had been less volatile than they had initially feared.

"I'm extremely satisfied, to be honest," Bowditch said.

"Coming into today, I was wondering where we would land with the mares-in-foal but I thought it was a genuine market again." **Cont. on page 5**

Continued from page 2 Yulong's seemingly extravagant \$2.05 million outlay is put firmly into context by the desirability, and indeed relative rarity, of Extreme Choice's offspring, with the Newgate resident's yearlings selling for up to \$3 million this year.

In addition to the positive test she was carrying following her date last October with the superstar stallion, who stands for a 2026 service fee of \$385,000 including GST, Miss Hellfire's physique and unflappable demeanour made her an irresistible package.

The team at Newgate, which sold her as a yearling for \$60,000 to Triple Crown Syndications, was understandably delighted to consign the sale topper on the closing day of the Gold Coast auction.

"She's a special mare for us," said Newgate's stud manager Jim Carey.

"We bred her - she had the 'N' on her shoulder - and we bought her back last year. She was a beautiful yearling, she was a hugely talented mare, we know the family well and her sister

[August Bloom] is in foal to Extreme Choice.

"She hasn't turned a hair, she's very straightforward. She was an elite offering and the sire's a freak, so if she throws one that looks like herself, she's onto a winner. It's no secret that it's a big effort to get mares in foal to Extreme, but results like this make all the hard work worthwhile."

Fairgray described Miss Hellfire "a beautiful mare", and pointed to the fact that her half-sister Xtremetime (Extreme Choice) was a juvenile stakes winner as another factor in her favour.

"She is a very attractive mare, and Extreme Choice has already worked with the family so hopefully she leaves a yearling that looks as good as herself," he said.

"I'm sure it will head for a yearling sale, and hopefully sell well. Obviously a lot of breeders want to try and get a mare in foal to him [Extreme Choice] so you've really got to be able to go to the peak to secure them, and her being such a good-looking mare was a key to it as well."

A short time later, Yulong again splashed the

cash on a mare in foal to Extreme Choice when they acquired Amen Corner (I Am Invincible) for \$1.3 million again from the Newgate draft.

The mare's racing career was abbreviated by injury after just one start, but her dam Augusta Proud (More Than Ready) was an early sprinting star with six successive wins as a juvenile for her former trainer Leon McDonald.

She has passed that precocity onto her offspring - her first foal Thyme For Roses (Redoute's Choice) was a stakes winner - so the family held plenty of appeal even before Amen Corner's springtime mating with Extreme Choice.

"She's a good, strong mare and if she leaves one similar to herself it will be a very popular yearling," commented Fairgray.

"At this stage, the foals will come through the sales as yearlings. Once the foals are born we'll assess what we do, but at this stage I think we'll try and offer them back into the marketplace. Obviously we can put a reserve on them in the marketplace, and then see how we go."

Continued from page 3 The best-performed mare up for auction was unquestionably Startantes (Star Turn) and she sold accordingly, as Widden Stud partnered with David Redvers Bloodstock to buy out their previous partners in the Group 1 winner - who is carrying a foal by Darley dynamo Anamoe (Street Boss) - with a bid of \$1.4 million.

Two years on from her slashing win for trainer (and breeder) Robert Heathcote in the 2022 Tattersall's Tiara (Gr 1, 1600m), Widden paid \$1.15 million for Startantes at the 2024 Inglis Chairman's Sale; but with some of their fellow investors subsequently opting to dissolve the partnership, the mare was placed back on the open market.

Given that she won five times in the city and was Group 1-placed on two occasions in addition to her Tatt's triumph, Widden principal Anthony Thompson valued the daughter of prolific producer Funtantes (Easy Rocking) up to \$2 million - so he was a suitably relieved man when the bidding stopped well short of that lofty mark.

"It's a rare thing to be able to buy a Group 1 winner in foal to a very promising stallion," said Thompson, an avid admirer of Anamoe with Widden having sold one of his colts to Ciaran Maher for \$1.1 million earlier this year.

"We owned a share in the mare but a few people in the partnership wanted to dissolve it,

so we were very happy to increase our stake and take her home to the farm with us. We've loved having her on the farm, she's one of the real favourites with the staff so we're excited to have her.

"Realistically I thought she was a \$1.5m to \$2m mare, when you compare her to what some of the mares off the track made yesterday. So we're thrilled to pay less than that for her. She would be a lovely mare for Zoustar and she'd suit a number of our stallions. She's very easy to mate so our options are wide open, and I'm sure you'll see lots of lovely mares out of Startantes coming back through the sales here in the near future."

Other notable lots on a solid day of trading included dual stakes winner Thalassophile (Not A Single Doubt), who was purchased in foal to Vinery's Ole Kirk (Written Tycoon) by Julia Ritchie's Bangaloe Stud for \$850,000.

Bangaloe Stud secured a prized share in

Extreme Choice for \$735,000 on the opening day, it seems almost certain that Thalassophile will be booked in for a date later this year with the hottest property on the stallion market.

"I've been investing in some really lovely stallion breeding rights, and I'm looking to buy more quality mares to enhance those purchases," she said.

"As a type, she will let down into a really nice mare. She's still in the early stages, but she has a lot of upside and her family is great as well."

Bowditch pointed to an overall clearance rate of 80 per cent, an average sale price of \$220,000 and a gross of \$66 million as reasons to be optimistic.

"I felt that they were really solid numbers," he said.

"It was pleasing that there was thirst all the way through to the end for the mares-in-foal. When a quality mare walked in, there was plenty of competition and a willingness to participate.

"A mare catalogue is never apples with apples. (We had) less numbers and a different type of catalogue compared to last year. So it is hard to compare, but the numbers we ended up with are above the expectations of what we thought we could achieve leading into the sale."

Ladbrokes Stradbroke Season shifts focus back to Eagle Farm for Sky Racing Derby Day, featuring a double-headline Group 1 card and three \$1million races.

After making every post a winner in the Rough Habit Plate a fortnight ago, Chris Waller's Kilman is aiming to be the first horse since Dark Dream (2018) to follow up with victory in the Queensland Derby.

While the Queensland Guineas champion, Brave Monarch, has opted to follow a path to the Ladbrokes Stradbroke Handicap, lining up in the win-and-you're-in Mullins Lawyers Fred Best Classic and coming up against a strong field including Graftersburners, Sixties, Beadman and Wodeton.

The Ladbrokes Kingsford Smith Cup field of acceptors boasts 11 different Group 1 winners.

The race is wide open with Jimmysstar, Fangirl and

Private Eye all vying for favouritism ahead of a strong pack including Napoleonic, Rothfire, Transatlantic, and Victory Stakes winner Splash Back.

Four two-year-olds will put their unbeaten streaks on the line in The Straight Sires' Produce as we get one final look at this season's juvenile crop ahead of the G1 J.J. Atkins on 13 June.

Pin Up filly by Pinatubo

Darley shuttler Pinatubo (Shamardal) sired a fourth winner from his first Australian crop when Pin Up Sheila led all the way in a Canterbury nursery (1100m) on Wednesday. Pin Up Sheila (2f Pinatubo - Sheilarized by Authorized) had won a Randwick trial last month, though trainer Tom Charlton admitted the small four horse heat made it difficult to know what to expect. "She had been a bit raw at the trials but settled in front today and then quickened like a nice filly," trainer Tom Charlton said. "I was a bit reserved knowing she is still learning. She's obviously gone forward and that's pleasing on the wet track. "There's plenty of upside. She responded to the pressure up front and will be going further

in time." Pin Up Sheila is raced by the Esplin family and made \$50,000 from Widden Stud at the 2025 Inglis Classic Yearling Sale. Her dam Sheilarized is a winning half-sister to MRC Bel Esprit Stakes (Listed, 1200m) winner Officer Bearer (Officer) and the mare's yearling colt by Jacquinot (Rubick) was knocked down for \$140,000 to John Foote at the Inglis Classic Sale in February. Pinatubo had sired his third Australasian winner on Tuesday courtesy of the Nick Olive-trained filly Voynichese at Albury. Olive had purchased her for \$30,000 out of the Canning Downs draft at the 2025 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale. Pinatubo, whose Australasian progeny are headed by Inglis 2YO Challenge (1200m) winner Global Goal, will stand the 2026 breeding season at a fee of \$27,500 (inc GST).

Front Rank makes stylish debut at Canterbury

A full brother to Cambridge Stud's exciting young sire Sword Of State's (Snitzel), well-bred three-year-old Front Rank made a winning debut at Canterbury on Wednesday for the Waterhouse and Bott stable. A three-year-old gelding by Snitzel retained to race by Sir Owen Glenn's Go Bloodstock, Front Rank had been given time to mature, heading to the races after four barrier trials, including two this preparation. Ridden positively by Tim Clark in

the 1250 metre maiden, Front Rank travelled strongly on speed before dashing clear at the top of the straight and cruising home to score by two and a half lengths. While Sword Of State was an elite juvenile in New Zealand, Front Rank has taken a more patient path to the races, a strategy that now appears likely to pay dividends. Front Rank was given a patient build-up by the Waterhouse and Bott stable, with co-trainer Adrian Bott pleased with both the ride and the gelding's professionalism on debut. Bott said Tim Clark rode the horse with confidence and was prepared to use his fitness early, with Front Rank sustaining the effort strongly through the line despite working in the run. The stable has deliberately taken its time with the three-year-old, with Bott noting the benefit of racing for owners willing to allow the horse to develop at his own pace. He added the gelding had derived improvement from two educational lead-up trials and suggested this time of year could suit a lightly raced horse building confidence through the grades. Front Rank is the third winner from four foals to race out of Group 2-placed Encosta De Lago mare In The Vanguard, herself a daughter of Group 2 winner Sharp (Danzero) and a half-sister to the dam of Group 3 winner Recuperato (Farnan). In The Vanguard visited Coolmore last spring and was covered by Snitzel's Group 1-winning son Switzerland.

Miss on Fire for Queensland Oaks

Fireball Miss (Bivouac) is on track for the Queensland Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) after coming through her final classic lead-up in good order. The Ciaran Maher-trained filly accelerated to an impressive victory in The Roses (Gr 2, 2000m) last Saturday to score by a long neck over Chispa (Savabeel) and Grand Omaha (Omaha Beach). "She stays at Tony Gollan's yard and I can't thank him and his team enough," Maher said. "She's improved at every run and will have a very good chance in the Queensland Oaks." Fireball Miss has the opportunity to become only the fourth filly to complete The Rose - Queensland Oaks double at Eagle Farm on Saturday, June 6 after Youngstar (High Chaparral) in 2018, Scarlett Lady (Savabeel) in 2011 and Ethereal (Rhythm) in 2001. In-form jockey Declan Bates partnered Fireball Miss for the first time when they finished second in the Gold Coast Bracelet (Listed, 1800m) on May 9 but they went one better in The Roses after taking up a forward position. Fireball Miss was bred and sold by Scott Delzoppo and Mimi Kleber through Vinery Stud (as agent) for \$140,000 at the 2024 Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale. She's a half-sister to South Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2500m) winner Femminile (Dundeel). Their dam Femme Fireball (Pierro) has an Anamoe filly foal catalogued as Lot 406 for the Inglis Great Southern Weanling Sale at Oaklands Junction on Friday, 12 June.

Farmelia win a positive sign for Skybird

Ballarat trainer Mitch Freedman is hoping a midweek maiden win by Farmelia (Farnan) is a good omen for stablemate Skybird (Exosphere) in the Kingsford Smith Cup (Gr 1, 1300m) at Eagle Farm this Saturday. Farmelia is a work in progress but was still good enough to win the Sportsbet Fastform Plate (1000m) at Caulfield on Wednesday. "She had been flighty filly early on and it's taken a lot of work to get her to the

track," Freedman explained. "She did a few things wrong today but she's open to plenty of improvement. I don't test them too early and I do a fair bit of riding myself. That way, I can get a bit of a feel of where they are and then all that we try and do is condition their bone and get them up fitness wise." Farmelia was bred by WA-based Peter Walsh and races in the same colours as his Group 1 mare Amelia's Jewel (Siyouni). He kept a share after selling her for \$140,000 through the Segenhoe Stud draft at the 2025 Inglis Premier Yearling Sale. Walsh had purchased her dam Amelia's la Bout (Hinchinbrook) for \$280,000 at the 2017 Inglis Easter Yearling Sale. She was a brilliant debut winner at Ascot but badly lacerated a fetlock while spelling and that called time on her career after just the one start. Amelia's La Bout was bred by Keith Biggs and her dam Dance With Zeel (Dehere) is an unraced sister to former WA sire Natural Blitz (Dehere) who won five Group 2 races along the eastern seaboard before retiring to stand at Mogumber Park in WA. Freedman is confident Skybird can play a hand in the Kingsford Smith Cup. She will get back as usual from the wide draw but appears each-way value at \$21.

Hong Kong beckons Beauty Swift

This Saturday's \$1 million Queensland Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) has been a long-range target for Beauty Swift (Pierro) ever since he won a Nowra 1600m maiden last November. "He's a nice stayer. He's progressive, and I think he will keep improving," Warwick Farm trainer Matt Smith said. "He's the right horse and was runner-up in the Rough Habit Plate last start. The top four seemed to be staying on better than the rest that day." Beauty Swift was bred by Simon Kwok who races the 'Beauty' horses in Hong Kong. "They're keen to follow a similar route and are hoping they can snare a major in Australia first," Smith added. "He is a very nice horse that has just kept stepping up and is getting out to

"They're always looking for horses to take to Hong Kong to be competitive and they would rather race them up there than here. It will probably be his final run for us on the weekend," Smith admitted. "We were lucky enough to be asked to train some of the Beauty horses, and you do that knowing they are eventually heading over there. He is a very nice horse that has just kept stepping up and is getting out to 2400m where he is going to be very competitive. minimum but he got a little bit too far back on the day and hit the line well. "He's higher rated horse now and we've come full circle this time. He's coming into this fourth-up, back in distance but carrying topweight. It's going to be tougher for him this year, but he's snuck up in the ratings and has earned the extra weight. He's still on the fresh side and was a little bit soft late in The Goodwood. In saying that, he probably didn't have the cover that he needed in the run. The 1100m might be his sweet spot and perhaps fresh and early in the campaign as well. His first-up form is excellent, but we're going into this three weeks between runs but he looks to go well at Caulfield, so we will try that again." Watchme Win will likely go for a break after Saturday's run and be prepared for a running double in the Wylie Hcp (Listed, 1100m) at Morphettville in September.

Apprentice title a Grima goal

A breakout winning treble at Randwick has whetted apprentice Siena Grima's appetite for more city success this Saturday at Rosehill. Apprenticed to champion trainer Chris Waller, Grima has ridden 19 metro winners this season and trails Braith Nock who is looking to defend the apprentice title he claimed last season. "Bridging the gap on Braith will be my focus coming into the winter months," Grima said. "That's definitely the plan and definitely the goal, so fingers crossed we can get there." Originally with Mel O'Gorman in Tamworth, Grima came to Waller on loan at the end of last year and has been closely mentored by former champion jockey Darren Beadman who is now part of the Waller team. Grima says

Beadman has helped critique and improve her riding, while top jockey James McDonald, who has a strong association with the stable, has also been influential. "It has been amazing, especially Darren. He is always watching, and I know I have to keep my riding good, or he will be straight on the phone. The best lessons are the ones that are hardest to learn, and he's been great helping me continue to improve. To be riding under his tutelage, Chris' watchful eye and J Mac' (James McDonald) as well has just been unreal." Grima's book at Rosehill includes five for Waller, including expensive filly Ernaux (I Am Invincible) in the Vale Sandro D'Amore Handicap (1200m), Man Of Worth (Sea The Stars) in the Ranvet Handicap (1500m) and Tron Bolt (Toronado) who is a dual acceptor for Sydney and Brisbane. With many of the senior riders in Queensland for the winter carnival races over the coming weeks, Grima is keen to capitalise on her opportunities. "I love riding against all the better jockeys as well, it helps me continue to develop and learn things," Grima said. "But while they're away, it's great to show I can ride, ride winners, and ride well when they're not around."

Three for Splintex

Darling View Thoroughbreds stallion Splintex (Snitzel) sired his third first-crop winner at Belmont on Wednesday when Chixfromthestix led all the way in the Reliable Asset Maintenance Maiden (1000m). Facing the starter for the first time, Chixfromthestix settled nicely in front for Lucy Fiore and kept kicking in the straight to score by two lengths from Beyond A Doubt (Anders) and Extreme Makeover (Safeguard).

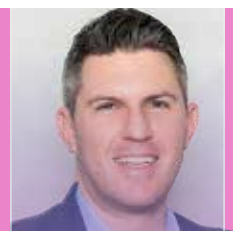
Chixfromthestix (2f Splintex - Minicoop by Sebring) was bred and sold by Gervase Park owners Chris and Andrea Gales for \$16,000 at the 2025 Perth Magic Millions Yearling Sale. She is trained by Josh Brown for a large syndicate of ladies from Kalgoorlie and Esperance, hence the name. Her older half-sister Whoa Nellie (Deep Field) is on a hat-trick after wins at Hawkesbury and Kembla Grange for trainer Brad Widdup and Mulberry Racing. "I like Splintex. They're racy types and this one's a natural runner," Brown said. "We thought she would be back a fortnight ago. The Darling View bred filly is from a half-sister to the dams of Jericho Missile (Smart Missile) winner of the D'Orsogna-Belgravia Stakes (Listed, 1200m) and Group 3 Eurythmic Stakes (1400m) winner Resortman (Helmet). Splintex currently sits third on the WA 2YO Sires' table behind Rommel (Commands) and Gingerbread Man (Shamardal). His first-crop also includes the Stakes performers They'reallsisters and Yamanex. He stands at Darling View Thoroughbreds. His fee for 2026 is \$7,700 including GST.

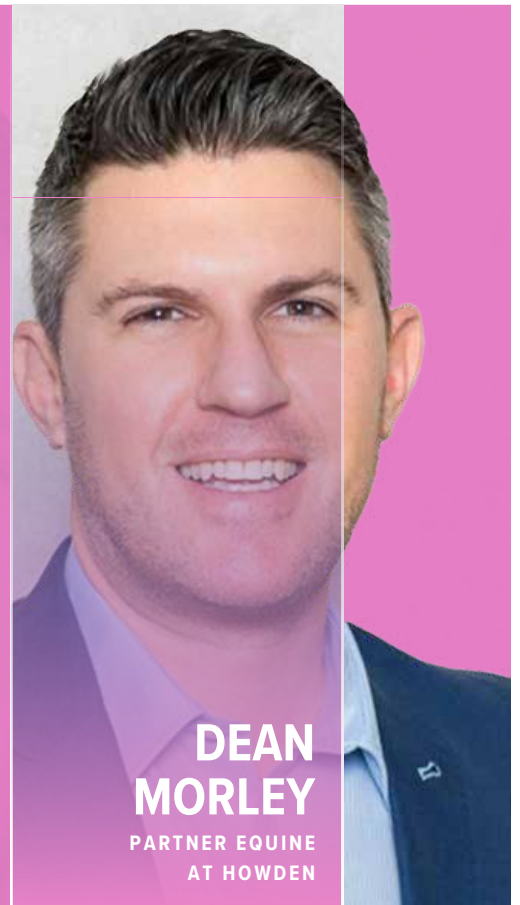

It's In The Blood

Fireball Miss

There can be no doubting the stickability passed on from the mare Femme Fireball (Pierro), nor the likelihood the owners who bought her last year will be rubbing their hands with glee.

Six years ago, breeder Simon Delzoppo sent the then six-year-old to Dundee (High Chaparral). A filly came out and as you might expect given the sire, she could cover some ground. Named Femminile, she beat the boys to win last year's South Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2500m).

But a year after the mating that produced Femminile, Delzoppo sent Femme Fireball to Bivouac, the star sprinter by Exceed And Excel (Danehill).

Now the result of that cover is Fireball Miss, who won Saturday's ANZ Bloodstock News The Roses (Gr 2, 2000m) for Bennett Racing and Ciaran Maher, and is among the favourites for next week's Queensland Oaks (Gr 1, 2200m). She's also helping her young sire's hopes in his tight battle with Farnan (Not A Single Doubt) and Ghaiyyath (Dubawi) for the second season sires' title.

Darley's Bivouac and Exceed And Excel were known for their speed, but weren't exclusively mad dashers. While both won the VRC Newmarket Handicap (Gr 1, 1200m), they also scored at the top level over 1400m. Bivouac took Rosehill's Golden Rose (Gr1, 1400m) over that trip, while Exceed And Excel claimed the Sir Rupert Clarke Stakes (Gr1, 1400m) at Caulfield.

Additionally, Bivouac has stamina on his female side. His third dam Camarena (Danehill) has come up in discussions only this week, since she's one of only three fillies to win the Queensland Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) in its past 26 runnings, scoring in 1999. She also ran third a couple of months earlier in the Australian Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m), and was second in a VRC Mackinnon Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m).

But still, Bivouac's other four stakes winners aside from Fireball Miss have won their black type over 1000m (Big Sky), 1100m (Intention), 1200m (Luana Miss) and 1400m, over which his star performer Beiwacht has scored in the All Aged Stakes (Gr1, 1400m) and Golden Rose (Gr1, 1400m).

Bivouac's oldest stock are only three, so the data field is small and the distances his stock might attain haven't been exhaustively probed, but the outlier in terms of stamina - and by quite a way - is Femme Fireball's daughter Fireball Miss. Her other win came over 1500m at Rosehill at start No.2, and she's one of her sire's only two winners beyond 1600m, from 45 victors overall.

Femme Fireball herself never raced beyond 1615m, and only covered up to 1350m in her

seven wins. Five of those were in city class - all of them at Doomben - a love affair continued by her daughter on Saturday.

Furthermore, Femme Fireball's dam and second dam - Subtitle (Fastnet Rock) and Paint By Numbers (Peintre Celebre) - won only over 1200m.

Her third dam, however, brings class and some decent stamina. Credit Account (Imposing) raced in the 1990s and while she won two Morphettville stakes races at two, she also won what's now Perth's Northerly Stakes (Gr 1, 1800m) later on.

Femme Fireball's sire Pierro (Lonhro), winner of a Golden Slipper (Gr 1, 1200m) but also a Champagne Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) and a Ryder Stakes (Gr 1, 1500m), can inject stamina.

His top three ranked performers are Arcadia Queen, who won two 2000m G1s, Regal Power, who won to 2400m and was Australia's joint champion middle distance horse of 2021-21, and Shadow Hero, who won the ATC Spring Champion Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m).

Pierro's other three elite winners include Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) hero Levendi, and VRC Oaks (Gr 1, 2500m) winner Pinot. He's also sired two stakes winners over 2800m, Sacramento and Grand Pierro.

All of which helps set out how Femme Fireball - successful to 1350m - could by next Saturday have two G1 winners from two runners, one over 2500m by Dundee, the other over 2200m by Bivouac.

"That would be pretty awesome," Delzoppo, the breeder of both, tells It's In The Blood. "I don't think you could get much better. Considering I'm a reasonably small breeder, it's pretty incredible having that success. Plus, pretty much every horse I've raced has won.

"It shows the quality of the mare, to have those two fillies. She went to a completely different type of stallion each time and look what she's thrown."

Delzoppo, a Gold Coast IT entrepreneur who breeds under his Aralet P.L. Banner - for his daughters Arabella and Scarlet - started in this game buying small shares in racehorses until the idea to keep one to breed from took root.

The 59-year-old now describes himself as more of a breeder than a racer. His broodmare band got away on him a bit at one stage, reaching to 10. But he was down to two until Tuesday when he bought another from a similar sireline in Miss Personality (Lonhro) at the Magic Millions Gold Coast National Broodmare Sale, for \$360,000.

That five-year-old is a city winner in Brisbane, as was Femme Fireball when Delzoppo bought her privately off the track.

"I like my Lonhro line mares, like Pierro, and Exceed And Excel," he says.

This time last year, Delzoppo cashed out. Fresh from her SA Derby triumph, Femminile - and her mum - were sold at the National Broodmare Sale.

Femminile, in whom Delzoppo retained a substantial share, went to Yulong for \$1.5 million, and was served by their stallion Lucky Vega (Lope De Vega).

The Coolmore-bred Femme Fireball was knocked down to Boomer Bloodstock and Paul Willetts for \$900,000, in-foal to Darley's Anamoe (Street Boss), with her value heavily spiked by Femminile's SA Derby.

Aside from producing stamina, the mare has another great knack: producing fillies. She's had five covers for five females.

After Fireball Miss, whom Bennett Racing bought for \$140,000 at Inglis Easter, Delzoppo sold her daughter of another Darley sire, Pinatubo (Shamardal), to Laurel Oak Bloodstock at Magic Millions Gold Coast for \$250,000. Both went through Vinery Stud, through which Delzoppo conducts most of his business. Now called Fiamina, the Pinatubo filly awaits her first start with Gary Portelli.

Femme Fireball then had a So You Think

(High Chaparral) filly who Delzoppo's keeping, while her new owners have welcomed a daughter of Anamoe.

"She loves having a filly, and they can run as well," Delzoppo says. "It was a tough decision to sell. It would've been great to keep both her and Femminile, but at the end of the day, it was good business decision."

The pedigrees of Femminile and Fireball Miss have something in common, in the repetition of a couple of noted stallions.

Femminile has Sadler's Wells (Northern Dancer) at 3m x 5f and Zabeel (Sir Tristram) at 3f x 5m.

Fireball Miss has Danehill (Danzig) in triplicate, at 3m, 5f x 4m, further scotching old fears about repeating that particular GOAT.

Bivouac brings a Danehill sireline and female line, with Danehill the father of Exceed And Excel and that Queensland Derby winning third dam Camarena. And down below, Danehill is the sire of Femme Fireball's damsire

Fastnet Rock.

Fireball Miss also has the influential Mr. Prospector (Raise A Native) three times, at 6m, 6m x 6m, through three different sons. Woodman and Gone West run into Bivouac's dam Dazzler (More Than Ready), while Straight Strike is Lonhro's damsire.

Northern Dancer's (Nearctic) influence runs strong, with six spots in the first six removes, evenly split in both halves, and 10 overall, while his super dam Natalma (Native Dancer) is also well at play with 13 mentions, the most of any mare in the pedigree.

Though fairly far back, Fireball Miss also benefits from a 6m x 9m, 8m, 7m of Flower Bowl (Alibhai), and an 8m, 9m x 9m, 9m of another wonderful American mare Somethingroyal (Princequillo), with both mares represented by two sons.

Native Dancer (Polynesian) is the dominant sire with 19 spots, one more than Nearco (Pharos).

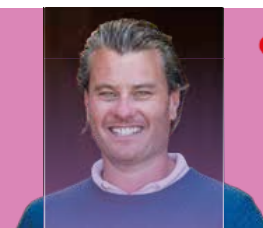
