Waller's Providence provides landmark winners for McDonald and Wootton Bassett in classy Derby display

The late Wootton Bassett's (Iffraaj) legacy has been extended by his first Australian-bred elite winner after Chris Waller and James McDonald continued their phenomenal run of success with Providence's win the Queensland Derby (Gr 1, 2400m).

In a quinella for Waller and the China Horse Club - Newgate Farm axis, the strapping colt led home Monopolistic (Savabeel) by 0.94 lengths, with Les Bridge's \$91 longshot Inspired

Legend (Dundeel) taking third a further 0.3 lengths away.

Chasing only his second win at start number 15, Providence was solid in betting as a \$5 second elect for Saturday's Eagle Farm Classic following his eye-catching third in Doomben's Rough Habit Plate (Gr 3, 2000m).

And he didn't disappoint in the \$1 million feature as he shot his earnings well past the \$625,000 figure paid for him by China Horse Club, Newgate, Go Bloodstock and Trilogy when he was offered by Bhima Thoroughbreds' at Inglis Easter 2024. **Continued on page 3**

Continued from page 2 Jumping from gate six of 18, McDonald had Providence travelling sweetly just behind midfield, one off the fence as they went at a genuine pace.

McDonald eased well wide as the field drifted away from the fence around the home turn on the Soft 5 track, and the colt responded with a brilliant burst of acceleration. He chased down the leaders to hit the front at the 300 metres and dashed to a decisive two-length break, while \$6.50 third-favourite Monopolistic followed him home.

Different Gravy (Ghaiyyath) produced a vastly improved run to take fourth at \$13, almost four lengths ahead of \$4.40 favourite Solid Gold (Savabeel), who enjoyed a favourable forward position but weakened late in her run.

Providence's \$600,000 first prize made Wootton Bassett - who died at Coolmore Australia last spring whilst standing at an Australian shuttle record fee of \$385,000 (inc GST) - another contender in an intriguing second season sires' battle.

He came into Saturday fourth on that table, \$599,000 behind Ghaiyyath (Dubawi) in third and \$749,000 behind top spot, with Farnan (Not A Single Doubt) and Bivouac (Exceed And Excel) the top two.

Waller celebrated his 201st elite success a week after he and McDonald took the Doomben Cup (Gr 1, 2000m) with Birdman (Free Eagle), and said Providence was an exciting colt with a promising future.

Should he keep developing, the son of MRC Thousand Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) placegetter Southbank (Fastnet Rock) will likely fill a hole for stamina on Newgate's expansive, speed-centric stallion roster.

"Great ride from James, good team of owners. They constantly support racing and they've quinella'd the race with two nice stayers with bright futures," Waller said.

"We just see Queensland each and every winter as a springboard for a lot of our better horses. And these horses are still on the up, so very exciting for connections."

Waller said Providence was more effective when ridden quietly.

"Very much so, and that suits our style of training as well," he said. "We're not hustle and bustle types of trainers. We just let the horses build through their preparation and in turn that's how we have to ride them on race day.

"If we try and ride them up on the speed it's hard because they're not used to it. So, yeah, races like this and grand finals seem to suit."

McDonald, who took his Australian record Group 1 tally to 140 and also landed his 16th Australian Group 1 of the season, equalling the all-time record set by "Miracle" Mal Johnston in 1979-80, agreed Providence was best ridden well off the pace.

"It's just taken us four preps to work that out, but we've got there in the end. He's ran out pretty strong," he said.

"To be fair, I couldn't have dreamed up a better run. It just worked out so, so well. He had such a resting run the first half and was able to just build into it when I **Continued on page 5**

"He's probably not a true stayer, but at ten furlongs, he's pretty sharp and he's just come a long way in a short time. He's a lovely horse to do anything with and a great attitude.

"It was a nice flying race and there was no real hiccup at all. He ducked in late, but it was because he was tired, but he's done a good job."

Asked about his charges being well-presented, Waller - who has 465 named horses on his books - quipped: "Most times. I've still got slow horses. We've got more slow ones than anyone, but yeah, in the big races, we certainly have had a good run."

With four starters in the Derby, Waller said the choice of jockeys came down to trying to give McDonald the best rides.

"So I've got to be accurate in my decisions," the master trainer said. "He doesn't care really what he rides, he just obviously respects our decision and that's why he ended up on the winner."

Thankfully for McDonald, Waller's judgment appears extremely reliable.

"You obviously put your trust in the stable and hope that we are on the best one and he's normally pretty right all the time and he looks after us very well," McDonald said.

Providence is the second foal and only runner of Southbank, whose filly by

Too Darn Hot (Dubawi) was bought from Sledmere Stud's draft at Magic Millions Gold Coast this year by Laurel Oak Bloodstock for \$460,000.

The mare now has a weanling colt by Zoustar (Northern Meteor), who covered her again last spring.

Providence became Wootton Bassett's fourth Australia-bred stakes winner, all of them coming in his second season of runners.

The late stallion has 86 stakes winners worldwide from 942 runners at a resounding 9.13 per cent.

Continued from page 5 A \$340,000 purchase at Magic Millions Gold Coast for trainer Michael Freedman, Michael Wallace and Kia Ora Stud, the well-bred Berzelius has spent most of this preparation at Freedman's Gold Coast satellite stable under the guidance of the trainer's brother and northern foreman Lee.

Something of a late bloomer, he debuted with an \$11 victory in an 1110-metre Doomben two-year-old handicap on April 22 before being a well-beaten fourth of eight in the Ken Russell Memorial Classic (Gr 3, 1200m) as a \$3.70 second-favourite.

That put him into the Sires' as a drifting \$31 chance, but under a good ride by Tommy Berry from gate eight of 16 - and settling well after the addition of visors and a cross-over nose band - the colt boosted his value greatly with a tough victory in the \$1 million juvenile feature.

Sporting Kia Ora's two-blues, Berzelius settled just worse than midfield, three-wide with cover behind an average pace on a drying Soft 5, before coming eight-deep as the widest runner when the field fanned around the home turn.

The colt knuckled down to his task strongly in the straight as he and Jenny Graham's \$10 shot Vantorix (Captivant) drew clear to fight out the finish. Berzelius won the battle, coming away to score by 0.32 lengths.

Tony Gollan's Martis (Trapeze Artist) was third, a further 1.19 lengths away at \$7.50. Top elects I Am Dirty (I Am Invincible) at \$3.70 and Blind Raise (Ace High) at \$4 disappointed, finishing seventh and ninth.

Bred by SF Bloodstock, Newgate Farm's Henry Field and Hollymount Stud, Berzelius could yet make a barnmate at Newgate for Extreme Choice, whose 19 black type victors

come from just 157 runners at a thumping 12.1 per cent, and who'll stand this spring at a national record-equalling \$385,000 (inc GST).

Fourteen of Extreme Choice's stakes winners have scored at Group level, with six winning Group 1s.

"It was a great win, a great win," Lee Freedman said.

"It was great for Newgate too as they'll probably stand this horse when he finishes.

"We came up here and he won his maiden at his first start and then he was a bit disappointing at the Gold Coast, but he never got around that track, and he needed headgear on because he was very green.

"Probably his last 200 was the best of the race at the Gold Coast, other than the winner, so we came here today thinking he wasn't a 20-1 shot, he was probably an 8-1 or 10-1 shot."

Freedman said Berzelius would likely continue to the \$1 million JJ Atkins (Gr 1, 1600m) at Eagle Farm in a fortnight.

"I think so, although he's a work in progress and he'll be a better three-year-old," Freedman added.

Berry said the 1600 metres of the Atkins "won't be a problem", adding Berzelius had benefitted greatly on Saturday from his gear changes.

"We really liked him heading into the Gold Coast, but he didn't really get around the track

and after that Michael said why don't we put a bit of head gear on?" Tommy Berry said.

"I said, 'Well if you're going to go with headgear, you'll need a crossover [noseband] as well, because he's still doing a little bit wrong'.

"He's a big baby, but you know, he's an Extreme Choice so we know how sharp they are. He's only going to keep getting better.

"He was a lot more switched on today, even in the barriers. He was standing there nice and quiet and focussed, and he jumped today and was able to get a good run.

"I had the opportunity to stay on the second placegetter's back or move out around the bend, but he hit a bit of a flat spot. I just wanted to get him into the race and he still did a little bit wrong in the straight, but he'll improve again after today."

Berzelius is the eighth foal of Secret Liaison (Artie Schiller), a dual Melbourne Listed victor who's thrown seven winners from eight to race. Second foal Styling City (Starspangledbanner) is one of the mare's four city winners and was Group 3 placed. The extended family contains four more Group winners, descending from third dam Surprise Affair (Blushing Groom).

Bred by Contract Racing, Secret Liaison has only had one foal since Berzelius in what's now a weanling colt by Newgate's In The Congo (Snitzel).

Headley Grange hits the big time with Kingsford-Smith victory

Redoubtable gelding Headley Grange (Exosphere) took his role as an Inglis Digital poster boy to stunning new heights when he became an elite and weight-for-age winner in Saturday's Kingsford-Smith Cup (Gr 1, 1300m) at Eagle Farm.

Trained by a master of second-hand horses in Joe Pride and well ridden by quiet achiever Adam Hyeronimus, Headley Grange lined up as a solid \$9 chance after a freshen-up following four consistent, if unplaced, runs in the Sydney autumn.

Most money went the way of Ciaron Maher's Jimmystar (Per Incanto), who firmed from \$4.80 to \$3.80 late as he pursued a first win in five starts since November, while Chris Waller's Fangirl (Sebring) was fancied at \$8.50.

And the market had it right, if perhaps not in the right order, as the only three runners in single figure odds filled the trifecta.

Jumping from gate three of 16, Headley Grange travelled strongly in fifth, one off the fence, behind what was a healthy pace, while Jimmystar from gate 12 had to contend with being three-wide without cover a length off the leaders.

Maher's Another Wil (Street Boss), who'd travelled in second, did well to hold the lead for much of the straight, but while Jimmystar tried valiantly to haul him in it was Headley Grange poking through the pack to the inside who won the day, if narrowly. He edged Jimmystar by 0.09 lengths, while Fangirl made enormous ground after straightening near last, finishing a further 0.32 lengths back.

Headley Grange's win capped a wonderful story of a horse relied upon for his consistent,

tradesman-like performances who can now be hailed as a Group 1 winner.

The five-year-old was bred by NSW's Bob Manwaring and put into work with Coffs Harbour-based trainer Noel Mayfield-Smith. But after three starts including a Grafton debut win and an unplaced try at Eagle Farm, a dispute between the two men led to Headley Grange being offered on Inglis Digital in November, 2023.

"I bred him and had an argument with his initial trainer," Manwaring said. "I said, 'He's too good for the bush,' so he said, 'Buy me out then.'"

"So we put him on Inglis Digital and I got a mate to come in with me because I knew we'd have to pay a bit for him, but the rest is history."

Headley Grange was bought for \$120,000, officially knocked down to HDB Bloodstock.

Sent to Pride, he won at Kembla Grange in his first start for his new trainer, then scored at the same track and his home course of Warwick Farm before a spell.

His next campaign in the summer of 2024-25 brought two wins - including at Randwick - and three seconds from five starts. After another Randwick victory, in a Benchmark 94 (1300m), he graduated to black type last June with victory in that track's Civic Stakes (Listed, 1400m).

Headley Grange then proved his class last spring by taking Newcastle's Cameron

Handicap (Gr 3, 1500m) and Rosehill's \$1.5 million Alan Brown Stakes (1400m).

Pride lifted him to the top level for his four runs in the recent Sydney autumn when plagued by wide barriers - a fourth in the Canterbury Stakes (Gr 1, 1300m), a fifth in the Ryder Stakes (Gr 1, 1500m), a seventh in the Doncaster Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) and a fifth in the All Aged Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m).

But Saturday's success in the \$1 million Kingsford-Smith finally confirms him as an elite winner, with Manwaring's Inglis Digital outlay hugely justified. The gelding has now won 11 of 25 starts for Pride, earning \$2.44 million in the process.

"He's up close to \$2.5 million now. It's unbelievable but hopefully there's more to come even in a few weeks in the Stradbroke," Manwaring said of Headley Grange, who's now a \$7.50 favourite for that \$3 million, 1400-metre handicap on June 13, in which he has 55 kilograms.

Pride confirmed Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1400m) starts for both Headley Grange and veteran Private Eye (Al Maher), who ran sixth in the Kingsford-Smith at \$13.

"He [Headley Grange] has been a horse who's had no luck all autumn," Pride said. "He's battled some pretty ordinary barriers, and it hasn't quite panned out for him, but it certainly did today."

Continued from page 7 “It’s the right time of year to have a horse like that up, so we’ll get him home to Warwick Farm for a couple of weeks, then back up here for the Stradbroke.

“But let’s not get too worried about that; just going to savour what happened today.”

Hyeronimus, who’s ridden Headley Grange in ten races for seven wins, was ecstatic over the gelding’s Group 1 ascension.

“He’s a beautiful horse, I actually really love him,” the 35-year-old said after his seventh top tier success.

“He’s such a kind horse and he has his few little tricks, but we seem to get on really well and the way I was able to ride him today was perfect. He enjoys being ridden like that.

“He needs to be bottled up like I was. And when I was able to dart back to the inside ... I was worried that the horses out wide had probably put too much of a margin on him.

“But within three strides, I look across and I’m in front and we’re at the winning post and it

couldn’t have went to script any better.”

Asked if the horse could win the Stradbroke, Hyeronimus replied: “I can’t see why not.”

Headley Grange is the second and best of four named foals for his dam Hard Go Jo (Hard Spun), a three-time country winner whose three runners have all won, and who died in June, 2024.

The gelding is one of 11 stakes winners for Exosphere - who died two months later - at 4.2 per cent of runners. His stock includes another Group 1 winner in the mare Skybird, who ran 13th in Saturday’s Kingsford-Smith.

Stradbroke to follow for Regal Award after Fred Best success

Highly rated punters’ headache Regal Award (Ole Kirk) became his young sire’s seventh stakes winner and capped a major day for trainer Phillip Stokes and jockey Lachie Neindorf in taking Saturday’s Fred Best Classic (Gr 3, 1400m) at Eagle Farm.

A total of 35 minutes after claiming the Lord Mayor’s Cup (Gr 3, 1800m) with Athanatos (I Am Immortal), Stokes and Neindorf celebrated a race-to-race black type double when Regal Award overcame a wide gate to score a dominant win in the three-year-old set weights event.

Jumping from barrier 14 of 18, the gelding was forced to travel three wide without cover just behind leading pair Grafterburners (Graff) and Skyhook (Written Tycoon), though the leaders set no records for pace.

In the straight, Skyhook, who’d come from gate 18, and Regal Award pulled away to make it a two-horse race, and it was the latter who prevailed, coming clear in the end to score by 1.06 lengths.

Ryan and Alexiou’s Skyhook held second at \$6, while Bjorn Baker’s smart filly Within The Law (Lucky Vega) was the best of the chasers, making good ground from near last on the turn to run a 1.75-length third at \$13. The \$5 favourite Brave Monarch (Brave Smash) finished fourth.

Regal Award started at \$18 - and drifted.

Withdrawn from Inglis Easter by his renowned breeder, Northern Territory pastoralist Viv Oldfield, and gelded before he’d raced, Regal Award looked an extremely bright prospect last spring.

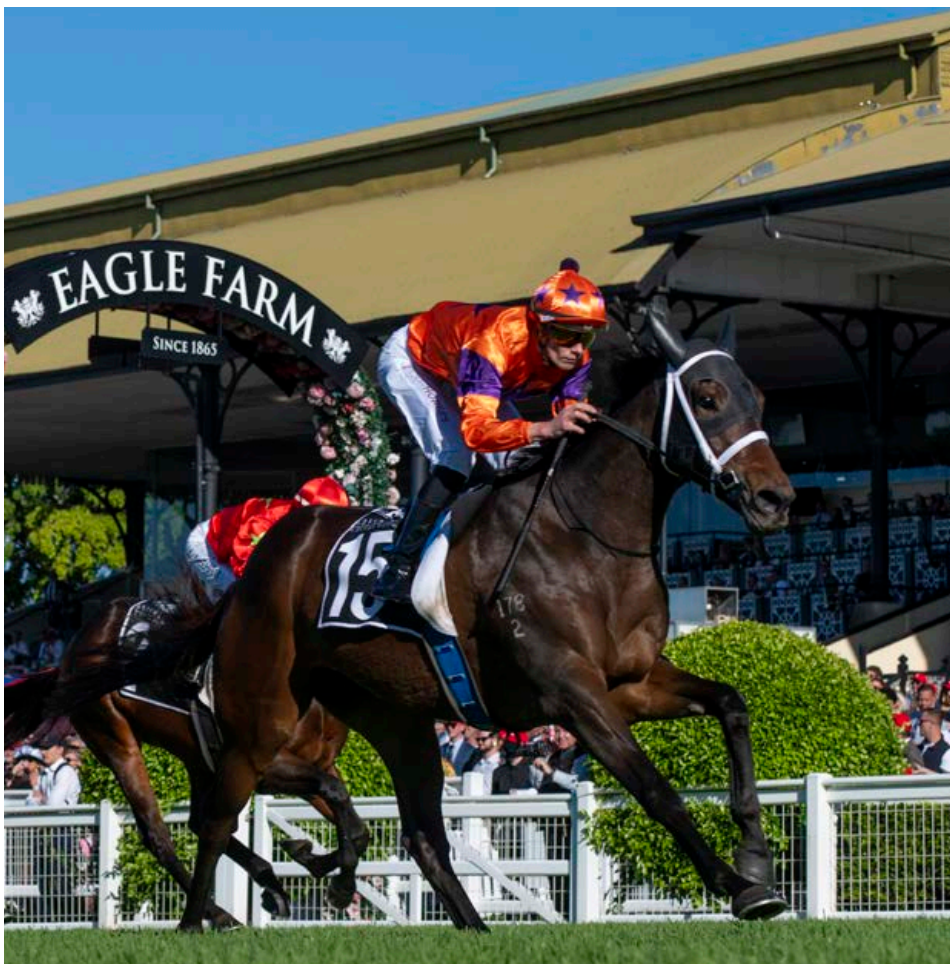
After a 2.25-length Sandown win at his third outing was followed two runs later by a thumping 7.5-length victory over 1600 metres at Caulfield, he went into Flemington’s Carbine Club Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m) as a \$1.90 favourite.

But his bubble burst somewhat when he ran a well-beaten second that day, and what followed in the autumn had been a battle to restore his reputation.

After a seventh at \$11 in Rosehill’s unsuitably short Darby Munro Stakes (Listed, 1200m), he was backed in to \$1.90 in Randwick’s South Pacific Classic (Listed, 1400m) but could manage only third.

He then was a \$2.70 favourite for the Hawkesbury Guineas (Gr 3, 1400m) but came fifth.

Thus punters had largely sacked him by Saturday but - with a tongue tie removed - he responded by showing his full ability, confirming a shot at the \$3 million Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1400m) **Continued on page 9**

Continued from page 8 at the same course in a fortnight.

"We've always known this horse had a lot of ability, but he's been very frustrating and hard to train, so full credit to the team," Stokes said.

"He's done well since he's been here and it looks like we've got to keep him here for another two weeks now.

"We're feeling good. His work's been really good, the horse is thriving up here, and it was just great for him to bring his A-Grade game.

"Let's hope he pulls up well but we'll probably have to find another rider because the 49.5 kilos, Lachie won't ride that [in the Stradbroke].

"It's very rewarding. The owners are very good friends of mine. Viv Oldfield and I grew up as good friends in Alice Springs."

Beaming after his double, Neindorf was able to joke about Regal Award's roguish ways.

"It's a great training effort," he said. "This horse, he's difficult - a bit like me when I was

about ten to 15 - very difficult.

"But he's maturing slowly but surely, and once again, like I said with the last fellow [Athanatos], Phil's taking his time and he's travelled him around, and as a result of that, he's mentally calmed down a lot more and matured, and he's a horse I know so well."

He added: "I was able to find a beautiful rhythm with him and just approaching the 700 he wanted to get a little bit keen.

"I had to just flush him out three wide because I know he's got that much stamina this horse and that's his best asset."

Regarding not being able to make the gelding's Stradbroke weight, Neindorf said: "I might be strapping. I'll give him a good luck pat and tell him to behave himself whoever does ride. But regardless, I'll be cheering him."

Regal Award is the first foal of triple Melbourne Group 3 winner Sovereign Award, whose Rosemont Stud sire Shamus Award (Snitzel) is co-owned by Oldfield.

The mare's colt by Anamoe (Street Boss) was bought by Stokes at this year's Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale for \$350,000. She now has a weanling filly by the same sire, but missed on a return to Ole Kirk last spring.

Last season's champion first season sire Ole Kirk, standing at Vinery Stud this spring for \$110,000 (inc GST), up from \$99,000, has seven stakes winners from 97 runners at 7.22 per cent, and currently sits fifth on the second season sires' table.

Purchased for \$170,000 by YLP Racing at the 2025 Inglis Classic Yearling Sale out of Milburn Creek, Tales Of Time races in the colours of Yulong Investments. He is the only winner from

four foals out of the winning I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit) mare Cinderella. Pinatubo will stand the 2026 breeding season at a fee of \$27,500 (inc GST).

20 for Wootton Bassett

Coolmore's late shuttler Wootton Bassett (Ifraaj) was provided with his 20th individual elite-level winner, and first top-flight winner in Australia, when the Chris Waller-trained Providence (3 c ex Southbank by Fastnet Rock) took out Saturday's Queensland Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) at Eagle Farm. Also becoming his sire's 86th individual stakes winner, Providence was a \$625,000 Inglis Easter purchase from Bhima Thoroughbreds for China Horse Club, Newgate Farm, Go Bloodstock and Trilogy. Bred by GSA Bloodstock, he is the first winner to come out of the Group 1-placed Fastnet Rock (Danehill) mare Southbank, who is herself from Group 3 winner Rezoned (Zabeel) – a full-sister to four time Group 1-winning stayer Preferment. Wootton Bassett died in 2025.

Two for Exosphere

Late Oaklands Stud stallion Exosphere (Lonhro) was provided with his second individual elite-level winner on Saturday when the Joe Pride-trained Headley Grange (5 g ex Hard Go Jo by Hard Spun) landed the Kingsford-Smith Cup (Gr 1, 1300m) at Eagle Farm. Purchased

by HDB Bloodstock for \$120,000 during the 2023 Inglis November (Late) Online Sale after having made just three starts, Headley Grange has career earnings just short of \$2.5 million with 12 wins and a further seven placings from 28 starts. Bred by RJ Manwaring, he is one of three winners from as many to race out of the winning Hard Spun (Danzig) mare Hard Go Jo, herself a daughter of the stakes-placed mare Go Johemma (Johannesburg). Exosphere died in 2024.

19 for Extreme Choice

Newgate's sub-fertile sensation Extreme Choice (Not A Single Doubt) chalked up his 19th individual stakes winner on Saturday when the Michael Freedman-trained Berzelius (2 c ex Secret Liaison by Artie Schiller) scored in the BRC Sires' Produce Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) at Eagle Farm. Bred by the Newgate partners, Berzelius was purchased by his trainer, Michael Wallace and Kia Ora Stud for \$340,000 at the 2025 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale. He is a half-brother to the Group 3-placed winner Styling City (Starspangledbanner) being the sixth winner from seven foals to race out of the stakes-winning Artie Schiller (El Prado) mare Secret Liaison, who produced a colt last spring by In The Congo (Snitzel). Extreme Choice will stand the 2026 breeding season at an Australia-high fee of \$385,000 (inc GST).

The Phillip Stokes-trained Regal Award (3 g ex Sovereign Award by Shamus Award) became the seventh individual stakes winner for Vinery Stud's Ole Kirk (Written Tycoon) when taking out Saturday's Fred Best Classic (Gr 3, 1400m) at Eagle Farm. Bred by G & C Pastoral Co and co-raced with partners after being withdrawn from the Vinery Stud draft at the 2024 Inglis Easter Yearling Sale, Regal Award is the first foal to race out of the three-time Group 3-winning Shamus Award (Snitzel) mare Sovereign Award, herself a full-sister to dual Listed winner Noname Lane. Last season's Champion First Season Sire Ole Kirk will stand the 2026 breeding season at a fee of \$110,000 (inc GST).

Five for Brutal

Savagery Vibe (4 m ex Kiss Moon by Malibu Moon) provided Newgate Farm stallion Brutal (O'Reilly) with his fifth individual stakes winner when landing Saturday's Helen Coughlan Stakes (Listed, 1200m) at Eagle Farm. Ridden by Daniel Moor for trainer Tony Gollan, the four-year-old mare caused a shock at odds of \$67 as she defeated She's Got Pizzazz (Zoustar) by 0.4 lengths. There was a further 0.2 lengths back to Poster Girl (Alabama Express) in third place. The win took the mare's record at Eagle Farm's 1200-metre distance to three wins and a second from just four starts. "It's been just an evolving preparation. I want to thank Cameron Cook and all of the owners who shifted the mare up here to us," Gollan said. "She's been a real work in progress and our team's done a great job with her. She's held weight all preparation, and she just kept putting her hand up to run again, and again, and again, and I wasn't sure if I had another run in her. I had her up for so long, but I just know how much she loves Eagle Farm 1200 [metres]." Bred by Orbis Bloodstock and raised at Newgate, Savagery Vibe was sold unraced by Orbis through the 2024 Inglis February (Early) Online Sale where she was bought by bloodstock agent Cameron

Cooke for \$22,500. She is the third winner from four foals to race out of the imported Group 3-winning Malibu Moon (A.P. Indy) mare Kiss Moon, herself a half-sister to stakes winners Kiss Mine (Mineshaft) and Mischievous Kiss (Into Mischief). Brutal will stand the 2026 breeding season at an unchanged fee of \$16,500 (inc GST).

Athanatos holds out in Lord Mayor's Cup

Pakenham-based trainer Phillip Stokes was provided with a stakes-race double on Saturday's Eagle Farm card, with Athanatos (4 g I Am Immortal - Mumbeilly by O'Reilly) landing the Lord Mayor's Cup (Gr 3, 1800m) one race before Regal Award's success in the Fred Best Classic. Ridden by Lachlan Neindorf, who would also be aboard Regal Award (Ole Kirk), the four-year-old son of I Am Immortal (I Am Invincible) narrowly held out the late run of Militarize (Dundeel) to score by 0.1 lengths. There was a further 0.2 lengths back to Future History (Showcasing) in third place. "He'd want to go to the paddock after this. He has had a really good prep, and he's just gone to another level since he's been here," Stokes told Racing.com. "He's thriving up here but probably a spell and we might aim him at something like the Five Diamonds. It's great that Lachie [Neindorf] has come up here and it was a lovely ride. I'm really happy for the connections." Saturday's Group 3 victory was the second career stakes win of Athantos' career, with the gelding having taken out last year's Chairman's Stakes (Gr 3, 2000m) at Morphettville.

Alalcanse back in winner's circle via Premier's Cup

Having not won since landing the Chairman's Quality (Gr 2, 2600m) in April last year, the Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott-trained Alalcanse (6 m Mastercraftsman - Albamara by Galileo) led home a stable quinella in Saturday's Premier's Cup (Gr 3, 2400m) at

Eagle Farm. Ridden by Tim Clark, the six-year-old mare defeated Bella Montagna (Belardo) by 0.3 lengths, with the runner-up a further 5.6 lengths clear of the third-placed Royal Supremacy (Make Believe). Bott was on hand for the victory and was complimentary on both the winner and runner-up post-race. "I had the poker face on there, but I was very satisfied, don't you worry. It was an easy watch from the top of the straight," Bott said. "He [Tim Clark] knows the horse very well, and you know, that's been her pattern right from the outset and Tim's obviously a very good tactical jockey on pace. But you know, if it's taking him a fair bit of work to get going, it's certainly not an easy task. And that's where, again, his experience comes in handy. He's had a great record on her, and I think he's delighted to get back on board. I thought getting up to this distance would be suitable. A little bit of softness in the ground we certainly welcomed today and the further the better for her. Bella Montagna is a very nice, progressive filly and they've both been up here with the Brisbane Cup in mind. Hopefully that placing today gives her enough of the ratings points that we needed to see just to make sure she's up in the order."

She's just got better each time I bring her back, she goes a little bit better. She loves her training life and she loves the people around her. You've got the John Monash coming up but I'd just like to give her a chance in the later spring, if she does take another step, who's to say we can't just win another nice race along the way, but she's in great order." Bred by the Devitt and Gordon families in association with Lindsay Park Bloodstock, Hearcomesthestar was purchased by John Moloney for \$150,000 out of Widden at the 2022 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale. She is the sixth foal out of the Group 3-winning Nicconi (Bianconi) mare Hear The Chant, making her a half-sister to the Group-placed winner Ndola (Justify). Zoustar will stand the 2026 breeding season at an unchanged fee of \$275,000 (inc GST).

Simurgh a potential Caulfield Cup horse after another win

The Lindsay Park-trained Simurgh (Phoenix Of Spain) could become a potential Caulfield Cup (Gr 1, 2400m) contender after racking up his second win from just three starts since arriving in Australia. The Irish import made it back-to-back successes as he landed Saturday's Benchmark 84 (2000m) by 0.4 lengths over Skippers Canyon (Belardo) with a further 0.3 lengths back to Oceana Dream (Ocean Park) in third. "I thought he did a good job today," Ben Hayes, who trains in partnership with brothers Will and JD, told Racing.com. "We're looking forward to getting onto a good track and seeing what he can do. We're also looking forward to getting him out over further. There's an [Benchmark] 84 at Sandown in two weeks and

then there's that 2500-metre [Banjo Patterson] at Flemington, so we've got some lovely options. I think he's got one more good run in him and then we'll probably put him away and save him for some nice races in the spring. He could be a Caulfield Cup horse."

Hot favourite First Chorus (Ghibellines) returned to her winning ways when she came from last to bolt home in the Benchmark 78 Rod Fenwick Handicap (1600m) at Caulfield. Sporting the colours of Spicer Thoroughbreds and relishing the Heavy 8 track conditions, the four-year-old mare sat last in the running for rider Jamie Mott before unleashing her final burst as the widest runner in the home straight. Trainer Lindsey Smith had expressed plenty of confidence before the race after the mare had failed on unsuitable firm footing at Flemington last start and with the moisture in the surface on Saturday his charge made short work of her rivals in the concluding stages, winning under a hold by 2.3 lengths from Enna's Dream (Winning Rupert) who also ran home well late but was no match for the winner. Smith was pleased to see his charge bounce back from her last start failure. "She dropped in grade to her last run and I was a bit more hopeful as the ground suited her and she has been feeling good the last few days," Smith said. "She has spent time down at the beach and she feels the hard ground, so she got it right today with

the scratchings and the track conditions. There is a race next week for her at Flemington, a Benchmark 84 where we can claim, so if it rains we will be here again next week."

Williams chasing tenth premiership success

Having partnered Obambulate (Tiger Of Malay) to success in the opening race at Caulfield on Saturday, jockey Craig Williams has pledged himself to landing a tenth Melbourne jockey's title this season. "I am going to miss 18 [Victorian] races being up in Brisbane over the next two weeks," Williams told Racing.com. "I count them by races not meetings. I am riding at the [Queensland] Oaks meeting next week and the Stradbroke meeting a week later so there are 18 [Victorian] races that I don't ride in and that I will be away for." The opening race win took Williams' season tally in Melbourne to 48 - four wins ahead of nearest rival Jamie Mott. "Every season we sit down with my team and work out what our goals and targets are - the Group 1s and the big money races," Williams added. "Then, of course, it's about the horses you have and where they are going to go and the ones you want to align with and to keep relationships going. Obviously, at this time of the year now and the position I am in, then of course it's [tenth premiership] a great thing to aim for. That would make it 10 and just one off the all-time leaders. The other thing is that [last year's winner] Blake Shinn is not here and that's a great help as he's such a good rider. We've got such great riders here but not everyone focuses on the premiership. Where I am at the moment, I do focus on it."

Portland off the mark in Australia with Lord Mayors win

There was a further 0.3 lengths back to Zaphod (Zarak) in third. "Portland's done a really good job this preparation," Smith said. "He was placed in a Group 2 and now he has won a Listed race. I think the tracks haven't helped him at times because they have been very firm and he's still getting used to those types of tracks. But he enjoyed the heavy (9) conditions today. I'll see how he pulls up but I would say he will probably go for a spell now." Smith is targeting a big spring with the son of Dubawi (Dubai Millennium). "I'm convinced Portland can continue to improve in the spring and he will get further," Smith added. "I think he could even develop into a chance in a race like The Metropolitan."

Ertijaaj remains unbeaten in Australia

Another import from the northern hemisphere, Ertijaaj (Night Of Thunder), scored on Saturday's Rosehill card as the four-year-old mare took her unbeaten Australian tally to two. An Emirates Park homebred, the daughter of Night Of Thunder (Dubawi) moved to Chris Waller from UK-based trainer Roger Varian after a debut third placing at Haydock and has not looked back, landing a 1500-metre Caulfield Heath maiden last month before doubling that tally with success in Saturday's Benchmark 72 (1500m). Ridden by Tyler Schiller, the mare defeated Island Dream (Divine Prophet) by 0.2 lengths with a further 0.9 lengths back to John Dory (Ace High) in third. "What a fantastic job she is doing," said Waller's stable representative Charlie Duckworth. "She was very dominant in Melbourne and has come up here and had to fight all the way to the line. But she has plenty of 'ticker' which obviously her mother had, too. We were worried she might be a little bit keen but Tyler did well to get her to relax during the

race. Ertijaaj is still learning, this was only her third start today so she can only get better. She obviously has a bright future and it is great for Emirates because when you are breeding from such a valuable mare [Estijaab] you hope her progeny are going to be good. But Ertijaaj is now a Saturday winner at Rosehill where her mother did the big deed [Golden Slipper win] so this becomes quite a special win."

Sounds Unusual leaves it late at Rosehill

Sounds Unusual (Unusual Suspect) continued his rise through the grades with a powerful late surge to land the Greg Millett Handicap (1800m) at Rosehill on Saturday. The New Zealand-bred five-year-old settled at the tail of the field under Reece Jones and still had several lengths to make up approaching the home turn. Switched to the outside, he produced a sustained finishing burst to overhaul stablemate Belle Detelle (Zed) in the closing stages and score by 0.4 lengths, with Mister Rizz (Lope De Vega) a further 1.9 lengths away in third. Purchased privately out of New Zealand and transferred to Chris Waller's Sydney stable, Sounds Unusual was recording his third win from 14 starts and pushed his earnings beyond AU\$300,000. "We were a bit worried whether 1800 [metres] was going to be far enough for Sounds Unusual," assistant trainer Charlie Duckworth said. "He always seems like he's looking for further, so that tempo is vital to him. The higher in grade you go, you generally get a bit better tempo anyway. If they handle wet tracks it's a big, old bonus coming into winter, and it looks like we're in for a pretty wet one." Duckworth also praised runner-up Belle Detelle, who is out of a half-sister to champion mare Verry Elleegant (Zed). "It's definitely in the family," he said. "When she won the Adrian Knox, she looked like she was going to be a superstar. She won with a leg in the air. Her manners have been the hardest thing to work out, so if she can get everything right she can win some decent races."

Back-to-back Hyperion Stakes for Western Empire

Western Empire's (8 g Iffraaj - Western Jewel by Jeune) latest success continues one of the most remarkable comeback stories in Australian racing. Offered through the Inglis Digital October (Early) Online Sale in 2023, the gelding was purchased by Yevrah Investments for \$150,000 and has since added more than \$2 million to his bankroll. Since changing hands, he has won the Gold Rush (Gr 3, 1400m), Northam Stakes (Gr 3, 1300m), two editions of the Belmont Sprint (Gr 3, 1400m) and, following Saturday's success at Belmont, back-to-back Hyperion Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m). Ridden by William Pike, the Grant and Alana Williams-trained eight-year-old scored by a narrow 0.1 lengths over Hoba West (Epaulette) with a further 2.5 lengths back to Rope Them In (Playing God) in third. Bred by Peters Investments, Western Empire is by former Haunui Farm shuttle stallion Iffraaj (Zafonic) out of Perth Cup (Gr 2, 2400m) winner Western Jewel (Jeune), making him a half-brother to stakes winner Western Temple (Dream Ahead). His record now stands at 13 wins and ten placings from 37 starts with earnings of \$3.68 million.

Having competed in stakes company at each of her previous four starts, Electron showed signs of a return to form when fifth in the Rangitikei Gold Cup (Listed, 1600m) at her most recent outing. Settled just behind the speed by Mereana Hudson, the mare burst through an opening at the 200-metre mark and fought gamely to defeat Khafre (American Pharoah) by 0.1 lengths, with Nigella Lane (Niagara) finishing strongly for third a further 0.8 lengths behind. A bargain \$1,000 purchase through gavelhouse.com, Electron has now won six of her 31 starts and banked almost \$200,000 in prize-money. Her latest success was the first stakes victory of her career and improved an already consistent record that includes placings in both the Easter Handicap (Gr 3, 1600m) and Cuddle Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m). "We weren't going to come here, but she nearly made me fall off when working last week and she was bolting around the paddock," Mynott said. "She deserved this and I knew she had a Listed win in her." Electron is out of the dual-winning Shamardal (Giant's Causeway) mare Chemistry and descends from the family of Group 2-winning juvenile Klokka (Marscay), whose progeny also include Queensland Oaks (Gr 1, 2200m) placegetter Tick By (Zabeel), Electron's second dam.

Shameless Star goes back-to-back at Wanganui

Shameless Star (Shamexpress) continued her rise through the grades with a dominant victory at Wanganui on Saturday, recording her fourth win and second in succession. Ridden by apprentice Toni Davis, the Peter and Trent Didham-trained filly enjoyed a soft run behind the speed before bursting through along the rail in the straight and spurting clear to defeat Roc All Night (El Roca) by 3.1 lengths, with favourite Circus Dancer (Circus Maximus) a further 0.9 lengths in third. Davis was impressed by the

manner of the victory. "I could feel her pulling at the turn and she has skipped home really nicely," Davis said. "I could see Chris' horse hanging outside, I thought we would get that inside run and we were lucky enough to do so. She is a really nice filly, she works so nice at home and gallops really well, we are really happy with her." Co-trainer Trent Didham said the daughter of Shamexpress (O'Reilly) had shown ability but was now beginning to put everything together. "Early on we thought she galloped better than War Princess, but she was just weak, immature mentally and physically, and now she is starting to put it all together. She has been flying at home. She galloped pretty well on Tuesday and the team at home have done a good job, she is probably the best she has looked, she has kept weight this preparation and she looks like she is going to grow another leg after a spell." Didham indicated the filly may have one more run before a break. "We will probably get smashed in the rating points now so if there is another three-year-old race, we will go for that, but we will just see how she pulls up."

General Menari salutes at Te Rapa

General Menari (Menari) continued his strong progression with a stylish victory in the Transport & General 3YO (1100m) at Te Rapa on Saturday, taking his record to three wins from seven starts. The Lance O'Sullivan and Andrew Scott-trained gelding had returned to winning form over 1200 metres earlier this month and justified favouritism with a powerful finishing burst from the rear of the field under Masa Hashizume. After settling last from a wide gate, General Menari was produced with 300 metres to run and charged over the top of Lubeck (Hanseatic) to score by half-a-length, with Miss Moet All (Russian Revolution) finishing third. Co-trainer Andrew Scott said patience had been key with the son of Menari (Snitzel), who has steadily improved with racing. "He just took

a little bit of making," Scott said. "He had a bit of a setback after his first ever start, he came back a bit fresh and lost his way for a start or two and then he hit a couple of wet tracks. He is just learning how to race. They went a good gallop today and set it up for those horses that were sweeping. To get down and pick them up was a really good effort. He is only going to keep on getting better and he will end up a good Kiwi sprinter. He is a horse we have taken our time with over summer and it was a really good win today."

Ridden by apprentice Hayley Hassman, the Mark Walker and Sam Bergerson-trained five-year-old settled just behind the speed before

"We sent him home from Melbourne and did a surgery on him for Kissing Spine at Waikato Equine Vet Clinic, so it's great to see him bounce back from that and win so well. We knew he was capable, but just with his back problems we needed to get that sorted. So well done to the vets and he's just a different horse now." Assistant trainer Reece Trumper said the stable had always believed the gelding possessed the ability to return to form. "We're so glad to have a horse like this in the stable," he said. "Dave purchased one horse out of that sale. We don't often go to the Tattersall Sale and buy them. But things didn't go to plan for him in Melbourne, we got him back to New Zealand, he did some dressage at Prima Park with Rylee Sheehan, and we've taken him along quietly. He won a Listed race in Europe, so he's a pretty good horse and it's good to see him do that today. Sam and I went back and had a look at his replays. They were riding him very quiet and having one last shot at them, but we thought we'd be positive today, and Hayley is riding terrifically well at the moment."

First for Matera Sky

Dea Veloce (3 f Matera Sky - Minnie Isle by Mikki Isle) captured the Aoi Stakes (Gr 3,

1200m) at Kyoto on Saturday, becoming the first stakes winner for first-crop sire Matera Sky (Speightstown). Ridden by Yuichi Kitamura, the Hiroyuki Uemura-trained filly settled prominently before taking command in the straight and holding off the late challenge of Hishi Islay (Maurice) by a neck. Tamamo Icarus (Declaration Of War) finished a further half-length away in third, while favourite Tagano Aralia (Mr Melody) could manage only seventh. 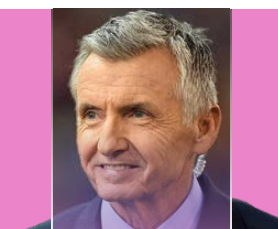
UK: Admirable Washington Heights takes out Achilles Stakes

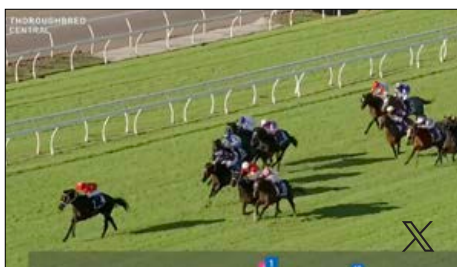

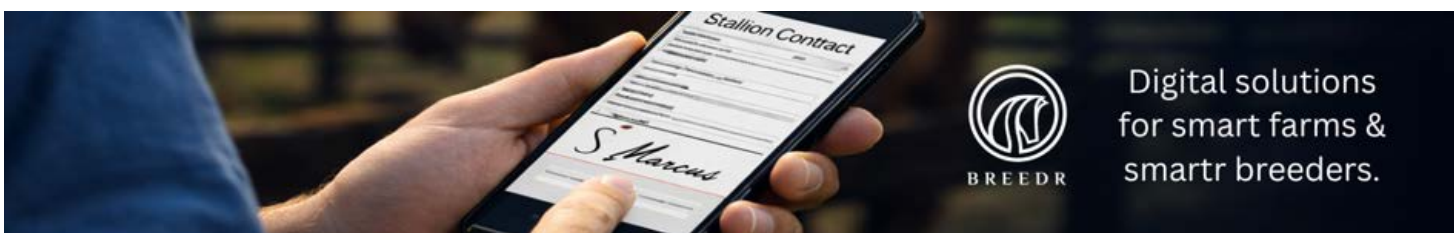

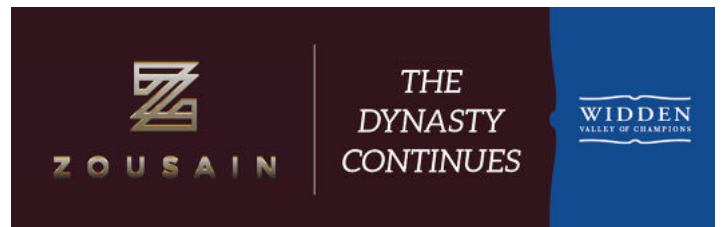
