Waller leans towards Chispa in Oaks trio

Master trainer Chris Waller is leaning towards Chispa (Savabeel) to continue her dramatic rise among his three-pronged assault as he pursues elite win number 202 in Saturday's Queensland Oaks (Gr 1, 2200m).

Waller will saddle \$7 chance Chispa, \$3.60 favourite Panova (Trapeze Artist) and \$11 shot Soverato (Vadamaos) in the \$700,000 feature, a week after continuing his stunning top-tier accumulation with Providence (Wootton Bassett) in the Queensland Derby (Gr 1, 2400m).

Following the Derby, where he had four runners and sealed the quinella for the China Horse Club-Newgate team as Monopolistic (Savabeel) ran second, Waller conceded his preference amid his multiple starters would always be shown by which one of them James McDonald partnered, saying "I've got to be accurate in my decisions" to keep the champion rider happy.

That barometer isn't available this week, with McDonald serving a careless riding ban after his win on Romantic Warrior (Acclamation) in Hong Kong's Champions & Chater Cup (Gr 1, 2400m) on May 24. **Continued on page 2**

Record-breaking Magic Millions Digital Sale topped by Vibrant Sun and Toropa

The appetite for quality stakes-winning mares remained strong at the Magic Millions Digital Sale, which concluded on Thursday with record results to become the most successful sale in the platform's history.

Strong domestic and international demand helped generate turnover of more than \$1.65 million for the 105 lot catalogue with a clearance rate of 74% and an average of \$21,742. **Continued on page 6**

But Waller on Thursday nominated Chispa, as slightly, the pick of his trio in the important fillies' Classic, albeit with the caveat that she'll need luck after a horrendous barrier draw.

His assessment reflects a stunning emergence for the well-bred filly, a homebred for New Zealand breeding giant Sir Peter Vela's Pencarrow Thoroughbreds.

Three starts ago, Chispa was contesting a fillies and mares' benchmark 64 at Canterbury at her fourth start, finishing well to run fourth of nine over the 1550m.

She followed with a 2.69 length win in a BM64 at Kensington, appreciating the rise to 1800m, and coming from near the back of the 10-horse field.

That run rated strongly enough to ensure Chispa started a \$3.80 favourite when elevated to stakes grade two weeks ago, when second in the ANZ Bloodstock News The Roses (Gr 2, 2000m) at Doomben behind Fireball Miss (Bivouac), flashing home again from her customary rearward position.

Expat Kiwi McDonald has ridden Chispa in her past four starts, and partnered Panova to her last-start top-level breakthrough in the Australasian Oaks (Gr 1, 2000m) at Morphettville. Waller conceded it may have been a tough choice for his fellow expat Kiwi for the Oaks, since "Sir Peter Vela is like a godfather to James".

In any event, Jamie Melham goes aboard Chispa but faces a stern test from the start with the filly having drawn gate 20, which would become barrier 15 of 18 if all five emergencies come out.

Still, Chispa's usual style of being ridden from the back, a likely stiff tempo at the front of a capacity field and Eagle Farm's long

straight could offset the negatives of the draw.

Asked who he put on top of his three hopes, Waller said, "Chispa, if she gets luck".

"Chispa looks the boom horse," he told ANZ News. "Unfortunately the barrier draw hasn't been kind. She's going to have to have a little bit of luck fall her way.

"But her run in The Roses was

outstanding, and she's by Savabeel out of a Galileo mare, which are both massive ticks."

Chispa's progress continues a run of success for her stamina-blessed dam Scintillula (Galileo). The Irish mare won a Group 3 at Leopardstown over 1800m at three, was second at two in the Curragh's Moyglare Stud Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m), and ran fourth in the Irish Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) and Yorkshire Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m). She then had six starts in Australia and New Zealand, with the best of them her last - a third at Flemington over 2000m.

Scintillula has produced three stakes horses from six runners, all full sisters.

Aside from her sixth foal Chispa, her second foal was the Grahame Begg-trained Butter Chicken (Savabeel), who ran second in Caulfield's Autumn Classic (Gr 2, 1800m), while fourth foal Waikato Girl won Eagle Farm's Princess Stakes (Listed, 1600m) for Michael Freedman in 2024.

But there's also speed in the family, hinting towards Chispa's turn of foot. Scintillula's full-sister Cuis Ghairé won two Group threes at two including Royal Ascot's Albany Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) and threw outstanding sprinter Danyah (Invincible Spirit), winner of Dubai's Al Quoz Sprint (Gr 1, 1200m).

Galileo's standing as a broodmare sire continues to boom. He's currently seventh on that table in Australia, by earnings and stakes winners, despite just 155 runners - the lowest

figure among the top 13, and with the six stallions above him averaging 516 apiece, with his star grandchild Via Sistina (Fastnet Rock).

Waller has won 21 Group One's this season, eclipsing his own Australian record of 19, set last term, with one of those coming from Panova in the Australasian Oaks at Morphettville on April 25.

She was bred by Scone trainer John Ramsey of Turangga Farm from his three-time country winning mare Love Me Quietly (Trusting), with the third dam being triple stakes winner Niagara Falls (Danahill). Owned by the Surace family's B2B Thoroughbreds, Panova was bought for \$325,000 at Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale by Ciaran Maher Bloodstock.

Panova's quality has long been evident, with the filly winning back-to-back Group Three's last spring at starts four and five, in Randwick's Reginald Allen Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) and Flemington's Carbine Club Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m).

In the autumn, she appeared disappointing when seventh in the Vinery Stud Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m), rising from 1500m at her previous run. But, as is so often the case, she showed the benefit of that initial 2000m outing by winning the Australasian Oaks over the same trip at her next run, surging home from near the rear after drifting to \$11.

With more than a month passing since that Oaks, Panova had a top- **Continued on page 4**

Continued from page 2 up barrier trial at Warwick Farm on May 25, running fifth in the typically quiet Waller way.

As you'd expect for a \$3.60 favourite, with the two second elects at \$7, Waller is certainly not dismissing Panova's chances at Eagle Farm, where she's drawn ideally in gate six for the husband of Chispa's rider, Ben Melham.

"She's come through, not just her win in South Australia, but the trip overall, really well," Waller said.

"We've always thought she's a decent horse,

and I think we've got her where we need her to be. Plus she's drawn well, which helps."

Ahead of a quality-stacked Oaks with many chances, Waller has also been impressed by Soverato.

New Zealand-bred, like Chispa, and bought privately by OTI Racing, the filly is a half-sister to New Zealand Listed winner Formidable (Shocking), who won seven times in Hong Kong as Tianchi Monster.

The pair has class in their third dam Strawberry Fair (Whiskey Road), who won what's now Rosehill's Coolmore Classic (Gr 1, 1500m), then left one South African dual stakes winner in Taineberry (Centaine), who threw another one in Jalberry (Jallad), who in turn threw three more South African black type victors.

Debuted by Waller as a November three-year-old, Soverato earned black type when second in Randwick's Adrian Knox Stakes (Gr 3, 2000m), then came a solid fifth in the ATC Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) before a 2.39 length sixth in The

Roses, steaming home from 13th at the turn.

Soverato has barrier eight, with Ryan Maloney retaining the ride.

"She's a Kiwi-bred horse, and her run in the roses was very good. She got a long way back and finished really well," Waller said.

"She's got a pretty good draw too, so hopefully she'll go alright.

"So all three of my horses are fit and well. I saw them all gallop at the Gold Coast on Tuesday morning and I couldn't have been happier with all three."

Sharing second favouritism with Chispa at \$7 is Maher's The Roses winner Fireball Miss, who drew barrier 18 for Declan Bates.

Soverato shares the third line at \$11 with Solid Gold (Savabeel), who's backing up after fading to fifth in the Queensland Derby over an extra 200 metres, and has gate four for Tommy Berry.

Eagle Farm was a soft 5 on Thursday, with fine weather forecast through raceday bringing the chance of an upgrade.

The appetite for quality stakes-winning mares remained strong at the Magic Millions Digital Sale, which concluded on Thursday with record results to become the most successful sale in the platform's history.

Strong domestic and international demand helped generate turnover of more than \$1.65 million for the 105 lot catalogue with a clearance rate of 74% and an average of \$21,742.

Group 1 Australasian Oaks winner Vibrant Sun (The Autumn Sun) topped the sale when purchased by Garryard Equine for \$465,000 after attracting 104 bids. Offered unreserved by Shamus Mills Bloodstock, Vibrant Sun won three races during her career, including the Australasian Oaks (Gr.1 2000m) and the Alexandra Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m) at Moonee Valley.

Perth stakes winner Toropa (Toronado) was the second-highest seller, knocked down to China Horse Club for \$360,000. The Jungle Dawn Classic (Listed, 1400m) winner of seven races is set to join the club's broodmare band and try her luck with champion sire Extreme Choice (Not A Single Doubt) this spring.

"The appetite for her was incredible," said Amelia Park Racing and Breeding manager Sharon King. "The level of interest from buyers and inspections throughout the sale was outstanding."

The Geisel Park Stud Unreserved Dispersal also attracted strong support, highlighted by stakes performer Duchess Of Gossip (All American), who sold for \$145,000 in foal to Playing God (Blackfriars), while Rosebank (Helmet), also in foal to Playing God realised \$80,000.

The Heskett Thoroughbreds Reduction Sale produced solid results, including a breeding right in Bivouac (Exceed and Excel) selling for

\$65,000 and Light Romance (Lonhro), in foal to So You Think (High Chaparral) making \$60,000.

Magic Millions Digital once again demonstrated the strength of the online marketplace, with quality mares and breeding stock continuing to attract fierce competition from buyers across Australia and overseas. The next Magic Millions Digital Sale is scheduled for 12-17 June.

Supplementary entries to Great Southern Weanling Sale

A strong group of supplementary entries has added further quality to next week's Great Southern Weanling Sale at Oaklands, with progeny of and siblings to elite performers among the late additions.

The eight supplementary lots include a Tassort (Brazen Beau) half-brother to Group 1-placed Military Expert (Redoutes Choice), a colt by Royal Meeting (Invincible Spirit) out of Group 1 winner RisqueDarci Brahma) and a Toronado (High Chaparral) filly who is a sister to stakes performer Modown (Toronado).

Offered by vendors including Supreme Thoroughbreds, Stonehouse, Collingrove, Shadow Hill and Phoenix Broodmare Farm, the additions lift the catalogue to 438 lots for the two-day sale on June 11 and 12.

Inglis Victorian Bloodstock Manager James Price said buyers could look forward to one of the strongest Great Southern catalogues in recent years.

"Buyers are in for a real treat at Oaklands next week," Price said.

Among the highlights are an Anamoe (Street Boss) half-sister to recent Group 2 winner Fireball Miss (Bivouac), a half-brother to Group 1 performer Extragalactic (Deep Field), a sibling to unbeaten stakes-winning juvenile Aristopolos (St Mark's Basilica) and a standout Anamoe filly from the family of exciting French three-year-old Concorde Agreement (Persian King).

The sale features progeny by more than 100 stallions, including Anamoe, Home Affairs (I Am Invincible), Ole Kirk (Written Tycoon), Savabeel (Zabeel), Too Darn Hot (Dubawi) and Toronado, alongside first-season sires such as Shinzo (Snitzel), Gold Trip (Outstrip), King's Gambit (I Am Invincible) and Ozzmosis (Zoustar).

Great Southern graduates continue to make their mark on the racetrack, highlighted by Group 1 winners Streisand (Magnus) and Well Written (Written Tycoon), while the sale has also become a proven source of pinhooking success.

All weanlings purchased are eligible for the \$12 million Inglis Race Series.

Half-brother to Lion's Roar added to NZB National Weanling Sale

The catalogue for NZB's 2026 National Weanling Sale has received a late boost with three supplementary entries added to the sale, which will be offered immediately after the 140-lot catalogue at Karaka on June 25.

Headlining the additions is Lot 141, a colt by first-season sire Paddington (Siyouni) out of Minnaleo (Black Minnaloushe), making him a half-brother to Randwick Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) winner and \$2.3 million earner Lion's Roar (Contributer).

The supplementary draft also includes Lot 142, a colt by Sword Of State (Snitzel) from Stella's Honour (O'Reilly), and Lot 143, a son of Ace High (High Chaparral) from black-type producer Light Express (Fastnet Rock).

All three weanlings are offered by Seaton Park, which will now present a total of nine lots at the sale.

Seaton Park's Scott Eagleton said the National Weanling Sale continues to provide opportunities for breeders and pinhookers alike.

"Cash flow counts in this industry and, with the right stallions, there can be strong returns through this sale," Eagleton said.

"We've found that by targeting the pinhooking market with the right sires and types, vendors can achieve excellent results without the ongoing costs of carrying horses through to yearling sales."

The farm enjoyed notable success at the 2025 sale when its Per Incanto (Street Cry) colt out of Listed winner London Express (Shamexpress) topped proceedings at \$190,000, purchased by bloodstock agent James Mitchell on behalf of Newgate Farm's Jim Carey and pinhooked through Inglis' Easter Sale for \$380,000.

Eagleton expects the Paddington colt to attract significant attention.

"This colt is client-driven and comes from a family that buyers know well," he said.

"Our clients saw the results we achieved last year and entrusted us with this well-bred colt. Being a half-brother to Lion's Roar and by an exciting first-season sire, we think he'll be a real drawcard."

Zaaki headlines thoroughbred presence at Melbourne International 3 Day Event

Former All-Star Mile winner Zaaki (Leroidesanimaux) will return to the Melbourne International 3 Day Event (MI3DE) this weekend as one of 110 retired racehorses competing across the King's Birthday long weekend at Werribee Park.

Retired thoroughbreds will make up 44 per cent of the equine competitors, highlighting

the growing influence of Off The Track (OTT) horses across Australia's equestrian disciplines.

Zaaki, who won last year's Yulong Rising Stars Challenge, returns to contest the CCN1*L class, an OTT-sponsored division exclusively for thoroughbreds. The multiple Group 1 winner will be partnered this year by Australian Olympian Shenae Lowings as all connections continue to pursue their long-term goal of representing Australia at the 2028 Los Angeles Olympic Games.

The popular Rising Stars Challenge, open to thoroughbreds that have raced or trialled within the past two years, has attracted another strong field. Among the entrants are former racehorse High Torque (Toronado), prepared by RV Acknowledged Retainer Sophie Fox, and Warrnambool trainer Matthew Williams aboard his former galloper Stardom Awaays (Tosen Stardom).

Jericho Cup and Grand National Hurdle winner Wil John (Reset) is also entered, while former ATC Premier Cup (Gr 3, 1900m) winner Wu Gok (Sebring) will compete in the feature CCI4*L class.

Racing Victoria's Off The Track program will again have a major presence throughout the event, including the Off The Track Masterclass on Saturday evening featuring commentary from Annabel Archibald and Melbourne Cup-winning jockey Michelle Payne.

Racing Victoria General Manager of Equine Welfare Melissa Ware said the event provided an ideal platform to showcase the versatility and athleticism of retired racehorses.

The MI3DE is one of more than 250 events supported annually by Racing Victoria's Off The Track program.

Kia Ora expands their broodmare band to support Farnan and Tropicus

Kia Ora Stud has continued its significant investment in quality bloodstock following the consolidation of its stallion operations with Vinery Stud, securing a number of high-profile mares and fillies to strengthen its broodmare band.

The Hunter Valley nursery purchased 10 mares across the Inglis Chairman's Sale and Magic Millions National Broodmare Sale, alongside eight fillies and three colts during the yearling sales series.

"We've been really deliberate with the mares we've targeted this year and a lot of them have been purchased specifically with Farnan (Not A Single Doubt) and Tropicus (Too Darn Hot) in mind," Wright said. "We plan on sending more than 30 mares to both stallions this season."

Among the headline acquisitions were Group 2 winner Sassy Boom (Spirit of Boom), purchased for \$575,000, stakes-winning three-year-old Gala Queen (Deep Field) for \$470,000, imported dual stakes winner Ippodamia's Girl (USA) (Stormy Atlantic) for \$625,000 in foal to Too Darn Hot (Dubawi) and multiple Group placegetter Vestas (Toronado) for \$600,000.

Kia Ora-bred Straight Sets (Prague) was also brought back to the farm after the stud unfortunately lost her Group-winning dam Sabatini (Street Cry) recently.

Bloodstock and Breeding Manager Shane Wright said the purchases were made with the long-term future of the farm in mind, while providing strong support for leading young sires Farnan and first season sire Tropicus.

Wright said the farm remains committed to supporting its stallions with quality mares, believing Farnan's best books are still to come, while homebred Group 1-winning freshman sire Tropicus will be given every opportunity.

"With our close relationship and major investment in Vinery, we also anticipate putting a fair amount of support behind Ole Kirk (Written Tycoon), Hawaii Five Oh (I Am Invincible) and All Too Hard (Casino Prince) for the matings that are better suited to these stallions also."

The investment reflects Kia Ora's long-term focus on building a high-performing breeding operation that produces elite racehorses.

Sunday's Apsley Cup meeting transferred to Casterton

Racing Victoria (RV) and the Apsley Racing Club wish to advise that the Apsley Cup meeting scheduled at Edenhope on Sunday, 7 June has been transferred to Casterton.

RV Stewards inspected the Edenhope track this morning following recent rainfall and deemed it unsuitable for racing due to damp sections of the track that were unlikely to sufficiently dry by Sunday.

Acceptances have been extended until 10.30am today for the Casterton meeting, the only change to the program is the 1850m Maiden is reduced 1800m. Trainers who have already accepted and don't wish to run at Casterton will need to remove their acceptance prior to 10:30am.

Grand Omaha chasing fairytale Oaks success for connections

Grand Omaha (Omaha Beach) will carry the hopes of long-time connections when she lines up in Saturday's Queensland Oaks (Gr 1, 2200m) at Eagle Farm, with her story spanning

almost two decades of breeding perseverance.

Former trainer and part owner David Brideoake purchased Grand Omaha's dam, Grand Journey (Good Journey), for just \$6,500 at the 2006 Melbourne Premier Yearling Sale. The filly went on to provide Brideoake with his first Group 1 success when winning the 2008 WATC Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) earning more than \$575,000 from her five wins.

Retired to stud, Grand Journey visited some of Australia's leading stallions, but failed to produce the results her owners had hoped for.

"The breeding thing was a complete failure with her, but we have always had a soft spot for her," Brideoake said.

Everything changed after a 2019 trip to Kentucky, where Brideoake was impressed by multiple Group 1 winner Omaha Beach (War Front). He later sent Grand Journey to the stallion, producing Grand Omaha, the mare's tenth and best foal.

"She is heads, shoulders and lengths above anything else the mare had produced," Brideoake said.

Now trained by Brideoake's son-in-law Matt Laurie, Grand Omaha has already secured valuable black-type credentials and enhanced her broodmare value after a strong third-place finish behind Fireball Miss (Bivouac) and Chispa (Savabeel) in the ANZ Bloodstock News The Roses (Gr 2, 2000m) at Doomben a fortnight ago.

Champion jockey Mark Zahra retains the ride and Brideoake believes there is still improvement to come.

"Because she is so lightly raced, I think she is still on the way up," he said.

"After her run in The ANZ Roses, you have to feel good about going on to the Oaks. Nothing ventured, nothing gained."

Rebel Royal set for Randwick debut on Saturday

Two-year-old Rebel Royal (Wild Ruler) will make his long-awaited debut at Randwick on Saturday after connections elected to bypass a midweek assignment in favour of taking on his own age group.

The Tulloch Lodge youngster was scratched from Warwick Farm on Wednesday, where three year old filly and stablemate, Lady Invictus (I Am Invincible) scored against older opposition. Trainers Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott opted instead for the Kia Ora Bloodlines to Headlines Handicap (1100m).

Co-trainer Adrian Bott said the decision was made to give the colt the best possible introduction to racing.

"He was going to face older horses at Warwick Farm and we felt he was better placed staying against his own age group, even though there are some more experienced runners on Saturday," Bott said.

Rebel Royal has impressed throughout his trial campaign, displaying natural speed and professionalism, particularly in his latest hit-out.

"His trials have been very encouraging and there is nice upside to him," Bott said. "He was tested in his most recent trial and responded well."

Drawn awkwardly in barrier 10, Bott expects the colt's early speed to be put to use.

"He has tactical speed and we'll look to utilise that. From the draw, it's probably better to be positive than negative."

Bott revealed Rebel Royal's debut had been delayed by a series of growth spurts, requiring patience from the stable.

"He's a big horse and we've had to give him time to keep furnishing," he said. "He still has improvement to come, but he's ready to get going now."

The colt will face a quality field headed by Max Lees Classic winner Seeiaye (Russian Revolution), Woodlands Stakes (Listed, 1100m) placegetter Lady Catalina (Written Tycoon) and impressive debut winner Lord Horatio (Stay Inside).

Ice Kool resumes with bigger targets in sight

Trainer David Pfeiffer believes promising three-year-old Ice Kool (Zoustar) has the potential to develop into a stakes-class sprinter as he returns at Randwick on Saturday.

The son of Widden's Zoustar (Northern Meteor) resumes in the Cornerstone Risk Group Handicap (1000m) after an impressive first campaign that yielded two wins from his first two starts before a credible seventh in the \$3m Magic Millions Sunlight (1100m) on the Gold Coast.

While the Sunlight may have come a little early in his development, Pfeiffer said the experience had proven valuable.

"It was probably a prep too soon for a race like that, but the form has worked out strongly and he acquitted himself well," he said.

Ice Kool has since won two trials and impressed the stable ahead of his return.

"He's a very nice horse. I think he can measure up to some of the better sprinters we've had through the stable," Pfeiffer said.

After being scratched from Rosehill last weekend due to heavy ground, Ice Kool is expected to get more suitable conditions at Randwick and will jump from barrier seven.

Pfeiffer's aim is to build the gelding's rating through the winter before stepping him up in class during the spring.

A Melbourne campaign is also under consideration, with the trainer keen to test the gelding down Flemington's famous straight course.

"I'd love to see him down the straight at Flemington," Pfeiffer said. "His racing style looks well suited and it could open up some nice opportunities later in the year."

Ice Kool runs for a big syndicate of owners headed by Blake Armstrong and John McPhillip's Strong Bloodstock after initially passing in with a \$150k reserve at the 2024 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale.

Pride chasing repeat success with strong Randwick hand

Fresh off a Group One victory with Headley Grange (Exosphere) in the Kingsford Smith Cup (Gr 1, 1300m) last Saturday, trainer Joe Pride will launch a three-pronged attack on Randwick's feature event, the Bob Charley AO Stakes (Listed, 1100m) this Saturday as he seeks back-to-back victories in the feature sprint.

Leading the stable's chances is seven-time winner Accredited (All Too Hard), who returns first-up after a summer campaign that included placings behind fellow Pride-trained galloper Coal Crusher (Turffontein) in the \$1m The Hunter (1300m) at Newcastle.

Despite his recent near misses, Pride believes Accredited is ready to break through for a deserved black-type success.

"The best version of him is more than capable of winning this race," Pride said. "I love the way he's moving at home and I've been very happy with his trials. He'd be my best chance in the race."

Accredited was placed twice at stakes level over last year's winter campaign and boasts

a strong fresh record, making him a leading contender here despite not having won since a Randwick benchmark race 12 months ago.

Pride's challenge doesn't end there, however, with stablemates Dragonstone (Mikki Isle) and The Black Cloud (Shamus Award) also expected to play major roles.

Dragonstone won this race in 2022 and has remained a consistent performer at stakes level, while The Black Cloud was competitive in elite company during the Sydney autumn carnival, including a close-up effort in The Galaxy (Gr 1, 1200m)

"The Black Cloud has been racing in stronger company and is well placed here," Pride said. "Dragonstone is an honest horse who is always thereabouts."

The field has been bolstered by emergencies Memoria (Caravaggio) and Wanaruah (Snitzel) gaining starts following the withdrawals of last year's winner from the Pride stable, In Flight (Flying Artie) and Bjorn Baker's, Monte Supreme (I Am Invincible), both of whom will instead contest feature races in Brisbane.

Oh Diamond Lil set to shine in National Classic

Trainer David Pfeiffer is confident Group 3 winner Oh Diamond Lil (So You Think) can return to her best in Saturday's \$500,000 Magic Millions National Classic (1600m) at Eagle Farm.

The five year old mare endured a disappointing first-up run in the Hawkesbury Crown (Gr 3, 1300m) when a breathing issue saw her finish at the tail of the field. A tongue tie helped rectify the problem at Scone, where she hit the front in the Dark Jewel Classic (Gr 3, 1400m) before fitness gave out late.

"That run at Scone has topped her right up," Pfeiffer said. "Usually she's very good first-up, but this time things didn't go to plan. Hopefully she's cherry-ripe now."

Oh Diamond Lil boasts an outstanding record over a mile and Pfeiffer is expecting a bold showing.

"The way she has worked leading into it, I think she's going to run a mighty race," he said..

Waterhouse and Bott-trained Surfin' Bird (The Autumn Sun) is another contender coming through the same lead up races having finished ahead of Oh Diamond Lil when runner-up in the Hawkesbury Crown and fifth in the Dark Jewel Classic.

Co-trainer Adrian Bott believes the step up to 1600m is the key to the mare's chances.

"Getting out to a mile is what she has been looking for all preparation," Bott said.

Both mares bring strong mile form into the race, with Surfin' Bird unbeaten in two starts at the trip and Oh Diamond Lil winning four of her five starts at the distance.

Spring test for Maher pair

The Ciaran Maher stable is expecting a rise in distance to suit both Zahrann (Night of Thunder) and Shockletz (Shocking) when the pair line up in Saturday's Flemington Community Plate (2000m).

Irish import Zahrann will be having his second Australian start after an encouraging first-up effort at Caulfield, where he produced the fastest closing sectionals in the race. A Group 3 winner in Ireland who also contested

Group 1 company in half a dozen starts, the son of Night Of Thunder (Dubawi) has some lofty spring ambitions.

National Assistant Trainer Jack Turnbull believes the step up and softer conditions will play to the gelding's strengths.

"His closing sectionals first-up were excellent and he has come on well from the run," Turnbull said. "He'll appreciate the soft ground and the step to 2000 metres."

Apprentice Jabez Johnstone's (a3kg) claim reduces Zahrann's weight to 57kg, and a strong performance could see him head to the paddock before being aimed at spring targets.

Stablemate Shockletz also receives weight relief, carrying just 51.5kg with Logan Bates aboard. The four year old mare was stakes placed when finishing third first up in the Golden Mile (Listed, 1600m) at Bendigo before an eye-catching fourth over 1800 metres at Sandown last start.

"Her run had plenty of merit," Turnbull said. "She lost momentum around the bend but her closing sectionals were very strong."

The stable expects the rise to 2000 metres to suit the mare, who is bred to excel over staying trips.

"She's ultimately a mile-and-a-half horse and beyond," Turnbull said. "The way she has returned this preparation has been very encouraging."

Astoria Brooke on track for black-type tilt

Trainer Tony Pike is hoping Astoria Brooke (American Pharoah) can earn a shot at stakes company when she lines up in Saturday's trackside.co.nz Handicap (1400m) at Ellerslie.

The lightly raced four-year-old is being aimed toward the Tauranga Classic (Listed, 1400m) later this month, with Pike keen to add valuable black type to the pedigree of the daughter of Listed winner Astor (Iffraaj).

"We want to get some black type for her, so the plan is that if she runs well then she'll head for the Tauranga Classic," Pike said.

Astoria Brooke has won four of her 14 starts and made an encouraging debut for Pike's stable when finishing fourth over 1300 metres at her latest appearance.

"It was her first start for the stable and I was really pleased with her run," Pike said.

"She had to go back from a wide gate and hit the line really well late, so 1400m will be ideal and off the minimum weight she's a genuine chance."

Pike will also saddle a pair of first starters in Pellargo (Better Than Ready) and Intan (Shamexpress) in the Lawn Shed 2YO (1200m), while Ashoka (Hello Youmzain) and Del Inquent (Reliable Man) round out the stable's Ellerslie team.

"Ashoka is a very genuine horse and back to Ellerslie it looks an ideal race for him," Pike said.

"Del Inquent has drawn to get a nice run behind the leaders and it looks like a race that sets up well for him."

Size matters in battle for the championship

With just six weeks remaining in the Hong Kong racing season, the battle for the trainers' championship is shaping as one of the most intriguing contests in recent seasons.

Caspar Fownes currently leads the standings with 60 wins, ahead of Danny Shum (57) and Mark Newnham (56), while Francis Lui (50) and David Hayes (49) remain within striking distance. However, champion trainer John Size faces a mounting challenge in his pursuit of a record-extending 14th title.

After saddling one winner at Happy Valley on Wednesday, Size sits on 47 wins, leaving him 13 victories adrift of the lead with only 11 meetings remaining.

The veteran trainer's season has been defined as much by near misses as successes. Size has recorded 61 second placings this term, 12 more than any other trainer, while his tally of 53 third placings is second only to Lui's 59.

A stronger slice of luck could have significantly altered the championship picture, with Size recording four runner-up finishes at Sha Tin last Sunday alone.

Despite the deficit, Size still holds a competitive hand for this weekend's Sha Tin meeting, with recent placegetter Fit For Beauty (Vanbrugh) and last-start winner Meepmeep (Not A Single Doubt) among his eight runners.

Hayes and Lui also need results quickly to remain in contention. Lui's hopes may rest with Hot Delight (Too Darn Hot) in the Class 2 Hong Kong Jockey Club Scholarships Handicap and last-start winner Thunder Kit (Rich Enuff) in the Class 3 HKU Jockey Club Tower Handicap.

At the top of the standings, Fownes saddles returning galloper Sky Deep (Deep Field), while Newnham has just two runners engaged and Shum will look to Lightness Of Music (Press Statement) to make an impact from a favourable draw.

With 11 meetings remaining, the trainers' title race remains far from settled.

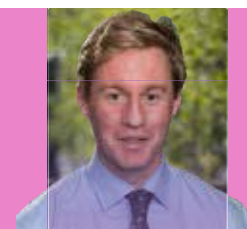
