Bargain buys strike at the top level

By Ziva Mullins

In a market where seven-figure yearlings command much of the attention, the 2025-26 racing season has provided another reminder that high-class racehorses are not found only at the top of the sale ring. Increasingly, they are not always found in a physical sale ring at all, with the digital market now a proven source of top-quality bloodstock.

A number of this season's stakes winners in Australia were bought for \$100,000 or less, turning modest outlays into black-type returns and, in some cases, life-changing results for connections.

The results sit neatly alongside the wider

value-sire conversation. If breeders are weighing up where to find value before a foal is even conceived, buyers face the same challenge when that horse reaches the market. The market may be a powerful judge, but it is not infallible, and this season's better-performing bargain buys show there remains room for good eyes, patience and a willingness to look beyond the obvious.

The most compelling examples are the Group 1 winners, with Inglis proving an excellent source for price point and return on investment, having produced several Group 1 winners through its yearling, Ready2Race and online platforms for \$100,000 or less.

Chris Waller was pleased with quiet trials from Autumn Glow (The Autumn Sun) and Lady Shenandoah (Snitzel), who finished third and fourth respectively. James McDonald kept Autumn Glow under a firm hold as she finished ahead of Lady Shenandoah and stablemate Autumn Boy (The Autumn Sun). "Today is about blowing out the cobwebs and keeping them mentally right and ticking over," Waller said. "We will start tuning them up after their second trials." Waller is also upbeat about Lady Shenandoah, who has strengthened physically and mentally following a luckless autumn campaign. The mare has not won since last year's Coolmore Classic (Gr 1, 1500m), but Waller believes she remains effective across a broad range of distances. A soon-to-be five-year-old, Autumn Glow will resume in the Winx Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Randwick on August 22.

Continued from page 2 notable of them is Sheza Alibi (Saxon Warrior), a \$10,000 Inglis Digital purchase, she has provided the clearest return, winning the Randwick Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) and Doncaster Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) at Randwick. Offered by Middlebrook Valley Lodge, a farm that has built a reputation for raising elite stock on its rolling hills, in the 2023 Inglis June (Early) Online Sale, she was bought by Fred Noffke and has since won seven of her ten starts, earning more than \$3.7 million. The Peter Moody and Katherine Coleman trained, three-year-old filly has built a formidable record, giving the public a new cult horse to follow.

Her rise also brings the commercial volatility of families into sharp focus. Her dam Sheza Gypsy (Shaft), a six-time winner, passed in twice on Inglis Digital before selling for just \$1,250 in 2025, while Sheza Alibi's younger half-brother Nomadic (King's Legacy), now placed in the TL Baillieu Handicap (Gr 3, 1400m), made \$160,000 at the Inglis Classic Yearling Sale. Value can shift quickly once performance starts to reframe a page.

Spicy Martini (Justify) gives Inglis Digital another major flagbearer. Bought by Edmonds Racing for just \$8,000 from Coolmore Stud, one of the defining sources of top-level racing and breeding stock, in the 2023 Inglis March (Early) Online Sale, the mare has turned that modest outlay into earnings of more than \$2.69 million. Trained by Toby Edmonds on the Gold Coast, she has won six of her 12 starts, headed by the Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1400m).

She also brings a deep page to the discussion, being by Triple Crown winner Justify (Scat Daddy) and out of the Redoute's Choice mare Extra Olives, with Group 1-winning champion Alinghi (Encosta De Lago) appearing as her third dam. A low purchase price does not always mean a light page.

Top farms and professional preparers continue to produce top horses, even when the market does not initially price them that way. Libertad (Russian Revolution), winner of the Winterbottom Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m), was a \$40,000 Inglis Classic Yearling Sale purchase from the Rheinwood Pastoral draft, a farm that has become an undeniable source of stakes success in recent years, including the Galaxy Handicap (Gr 1, 1100m) winner Private Harry (Harry Angel). Libertad later made \$210,000 to Annabel Neasham Racing at the Inglis Ready2Race Sale and has since won five races and almost \$1.7 million, with his record including the Winterbottom, Victory Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m), San Domenico Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) and Kindergarten Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m). He will stand his first season at stud at Blue Gum Farm in Victoria this year at a fee of \$9,000.

Streisand (Magnus) has been one of the most exciting two-year-olds of the season and another powerful advertisement for the

sub-\$100,000 market. Bought for \$22,000 by Northmore and Waterford from Yarran Thoroughbreds at the 2024 Inglis Great Southern Weanling Sale, she was later resold for \$100,000 to Shane McGrath Bloodstock and Clinton McDonald Racing from Northmore Thoroughbreds' draft at the 2025 Inglis Premier Yearling Sale. Now racing for Yulong, the filly has already earned more than \$2.42 million, winning the Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) and Blue Diamond Prelude (Gr 2, 1100m), also finishing runner-up in the Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m). While there was already black type in the family, Streisand is clearly the horse who has done most to elevate the page, her juvenile Group 1 success changing the commercial profile of the pedigree, with her dam Zouper Star (Zoustar) subsequently purchased by Yulong Investments for \$800,000 at the 2026 Inglis Chairman's Sale.

Idle Flyer (Dundeel) adds another Inglis-sourced Group

Bought by Matthew Smith Racing and Randwick Bloodstock Agency for \$70,000 from Torryburn Stud's draft at the 2023 Inglis Classic Yearling Sale, the mare has developed into a high-class performer for trainer Matthew Smith. She has won eight of her 15 starts and earned more than \$1.27 million, with her Queen Of The Turf Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) victory at Randwick following wins in the Emancipation Stakes (Gr 2, 1500m) and Angst Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m). Her page is littered with Group 1 performers, with close relations including Tom Kitten (Harry Angel), Desert Lightning (Pride Of Dubai), Gathering (Tale Of The Cat) and international elite-level mare In Italian (Dubawi).

They were joined at the top level by Sepals (Calyx), an \$80,000 Inglis Classic Yearling Sale purchase for Cliff Brown Racing from Vinery Stud's draft. The gelding's Sir Rupert Clarke Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) victory at Caulfield came from the first foal out of What's New (Casino

Prince), Singapore's champion four-year-old and older mare of 2019, although the page may have appeared light to sections of the market at the time.

New Zealand has also played its part in producing bargain Group 1 winners. Wigmore (Sweynesse), winner of the South Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2518m), was bought by K T Myers for just NZ\$25,000 at the 2024 NZB Karaka Book 2 Sale before progressing through New Zealand and joining Phillip Stokes in Australia. The gelding has earned more than NZ\$64,000 and A\$552,000, having also finished fourth in the New Zealand Derby (Gr 1, 2400m). His dam Del Mondo (More Than Ready) had already produced New Zealand Cup (Gr 3, 3200m) winner Mondorani (Burgundy), while his third dam is VRC Oaks (Gr 1, 2500m) and 1,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Arborea (Imperial Prince).

Globe (Charm Spirit) offered another striking example. Bought by J Naito for

NZ\$22,000 at the 2020 NZB Karaka Book 2 Sale, the gelding turned that modest yearling price into victory in the Might And Power Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) at Caulfield, defeating Treasurethe Moment (Alabama Express) by three lengths. Trained by Mick Price and Michael Kent Jnr, he has now won six races and more than \$1.2 million, with his record also including the Cranbourne Cup (Listed, 1600m). His unraced dam Bonnie Doon (Don Eduardo) is a sister to dual Group 1 winner Booming.

One clear theme is that quality bloodstock continues to come from quality sources and proper, deep pedigrees. The price point may have been modest, but many of the best performers were offered by proven farms, professional preparers and respected vendors, and came from families with the depth to support high-level performance. Value is not always found by looking away from quality, but by recognising it before the wider market does.

Cosmic Crusader set for Bletchingly

Group 1 winner Cosmic Crusader (Maurice) will make his Melbourne debut in the last stakes race of the Melbourne season, the Bletchingly Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) at Caulfield. The Bob Peters-owned gelding was transferred from Michael Grantham in Western Australia to Andrea Leek's Pakenham stable in May ahead of a spring campaign after winning last year's Northerly Stakes (Gr 1, 1800m) before finishing runner-up to Rey Magnerio (Magnus) in the \$1.5m Gold Rush (Gr 3, 1400m). Leek has been pleased with the transition. "I think he loves it," Leek said. "He seems very happy and we're just looking forward to seeing what he can do on Saturday. "It's a bit short of his (best) distance, but you've got to start somewhere and it just looked like a nice starting point." Peters said the five-year-old would progress to the Lawrence Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) before tackling the Memsie Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) third-up. Cosmic Crusader has won eight of his 17 starts and earned more than \$1.5 million.

Wilson-Taylor set for New Zealand stint

Group 1-winning jockey Kyle Wilson-Taylor will ride Yuuki (Doubtland) in Saturday's Lightning Stakes (Listed, 1050m) at Morphettville before beginning an extended stint in New Zealand. The 26-year-old, Brisbane based hoop will

partner the Tim Fitzsimmons-trained filly through his association with Elvin Bloodstock, having ridden Golden Monkey (Star Turn) for the same connections in Singapore in 2024. Saturday will mark Wilson-Taylor's first appearance in Adelaide, with Fitzsimmons booking him for three rides. He will then base himself between Matamata and Cambridge during New Zealand's spring and summer carnivals, riding for stables including Lance O'Sullivan, Andrew Scott and Te Akau. Wilson-Taylor's career highlights include victory aboard Palaisipan (So You Think) in the 2023 Tattersall's Tiara (Gr 1, 1400m).

King calls time on racing career

Champion jockey-turned-trainer Steven King will relinquish his trainer's licence at the end of the season, bringing his 40-year racing career to a close. King rode more than 1600 winners, including 50 at Group 1 level, before retiring from the saddle in 2017. His greatest successes came aboard Let's Elope (Nassipour), partnering the Bart Cummings-trained mare to victories in the 1991 Caulfield Cup (Gr 1, 2400m) and Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m). King also won two Victoria Derbys (Gr 1, 2500m), the 2006 Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) aboard Fields Of Omagh (Rubiton) and the inaugural Hong Kong Sprint aboard Fairy King Prawn (Danehill). The 57-year-old began training at Flemington in 2021, preparing 15 winners from a small team whilst trading many overseas.

Fellow three year old, Ninja (Farnan) placed second ahead of Autumn Glow (The Autumn Glow) third, Lady Shenandoah (Snitzel) fourth, while Autumn Boy (The Autumn Sun) finished fifth, over 9 lengths behind Napoleonic. Napoleonic is being prepared to resume in the Missile Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) at Randwick on August 8

Soulcombe pleases in trial return

Injury-plagued stayer Soulcombe (Frankel) made an encouraging return to the trials at Randwick, finishing third over 900 metres. The Chris Waller-trained seven-year-old has not raced since finishing runner-up in the 2024 Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) behind Without A Fight (Teofilo) and has since suffered two tendon injuries. "He's gone back out, then come back in. Chris has done an incredible job with him," part-owner John O'Neill told SEN. "Today was a bit of a nervous day for all of the owners, but it looks like his trial was good." Soulcombe finished less than a length behind heat winner, two year old Screen Icon (Nicconi).

Barnavara leads Waller trial highlights

Yulong-owned mare Barnavara (Calyx) made an encouraging return when winning a 900-metre trial at Randwick on Monday. In her second preparation for Chris Waller, her only Australian start was a fourth placing in the Neville Sellwood Stakes (Gr.2, 2000m), the French Group 1 winner clocked 58.06 seconds to defeat stablemate Wootton Verni (Wootton Bassett) by 2.79 lengths. Triple Group One winner Aeliana (NZ) (Castelvecchio) finished fourth, while dual Group One winner Ohope Wins (NZ) (Ocean Park) was fifth. Trainer Chris Waller said the trials were designed to build fitness ahead of the spring, but was particularly encouraged by Barnavara's progress after her first Australian preparation. "She has put on about thirty kilos, so she looks like an Australian horse," Waller said. "James is rapt. He says she feels like a completely different horse. That's exciting." Barnavara was purchased by Yulong for 4.8 million guineas, approximately A\$10.18 million, at the 2025 Tattersalls December Mares Sale, making her the highest-priced filly in training sold worldwide that year.

Pocketfullofcash impresses on debut

Rich Enuff (Written Tycoon) sired another promising juvenile when Pocketfullofcash scored impressively on debut at Pakenham on Monday. Trained by Reece Goodwin and ridden by Lachlan Neindorf, the two-year-old justified strong market support in the 1000-metre maiden, leading throughout to win by 2.5 lengths. Bred and retained to race by Graeme Gathercole's Graebar Park, Pocketfullofcash is the third foal and third winner out of stakes-winning Bel Esprit (Royal Academy) mare

Belwazi. He is a brother-in-blood to Rich Enuff's Group 3 winner Rich Fortune, who was also bred and raced by the Gathercole family. Belwazi died last year, with her final foal a rising two-year-old colt by Diatonic (Lord Kanaloa) named Clear Tones. Rich Enuff has sired 11 stakes winners and boasts over 68 per cent winners-to-runners strike rate.

Nolen reaches Pakenham century

Luke Nolen recorded his 100th winner at Pakenham when guiding debutant Jundah (Ole Kirk) to victory for Peter Moody and Katherine Coleman. Jundah, a \$40k purchase from Morningside at the 2024 William Inglis Melbourne Premier Yearling Sale was having just its second start and provided the first of a race to race treble for Nolan who finished with 102 winners at track. Nolen became the sixth jockey to reach the century milestone at the track and only the second to ride 100 winners at both Pakenham and Cranbourne.

Lismore meeting transferred to Grafton

Friday's Lismore meeting has been transferred to Grafton after the track was deemed unsuitable for racing. Lismore received 6mm of rain in the previous 24 hours, taking its seven-day total to 69mm. Several race distances have been amended for the revised Grafton program, while nominations for all races have been extended until 11am on Tuesday.



New Zealand

NZ horse of the Year event details

New Zealand Thoroughbred Racing (NZTR) has confirmed the 2025-26 New Zealand Thoroughbred Horse of the Year Awards will be held at the New Zealand International Convention Centre in Auckland on September 6. The black-tie event will celebrate the season's leading horses and participants, culminating in the presentation of the New Zealand Horse of the Year title. Individual tickets are priced at NZ\$250, with tables of ten available for NZ\$2,250. Tickets are available through the NZTR website.

Well Written set for Sydney spring campaign

Unbeaten filly Well Written (Written Tycoon) will begin her spring campaign in the Proisir Plate (Gr 1, 1400m) at Ellerslie on September 5 before heading to Sydney. Trainer Stephen Marsh said the four-year-old had strengthened considerably during her break and would trial at Te Rapa on August 8. Well Written could contest either the Silver Eagle (Gr 3, 1300m) or Epsom Handicap (Gr 1, 1600m) before targeting the \$10 million Golden Eagle (Gr 1, 1500m). The Yulong-owned filly was unbeaten in six starts last season, winning the New Zealand 1000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m), Auckland Guineas (Gr 2, 1400m), \$1.5m Karaka Millions 3YO (1600m) and \$4m NZB Kiwi (1500m).

Strawbridge celebrates first treble

Apprentice Ashlee Strawbridge recorded the first treble of her career with victories aboard Shawshank (El Roca), Magnastar (Magna Grecia) and Sir Sterling (Iffraaj) on Sunday at Oamaru. The 20-year-old partnered Samantha Wynne-trained Shawshank to victory over 1400 metres before scoring aboard Robert Dennis-trained pair Magnastar and Sir Sterling over 1200 metres. The milestone followed a challenging season for Strawbridge, who spent time sidelined after suffering concussion in a race fall last year. She returned gradually through the trials while working with a sports psychologist to rebuild her confidence. "It was awesome, it has been a long time coming," Strawbridge said.



Asia

Monroe Walk wins 3 from 3

Three-year-old filly Monroe Walk (Kizuna) extended her unbeaten record to three when scoring by 3.5 lengths over 1800 metres at Hakodate. Monroe Walk is the second Japanese winner out of 2018 Thousand Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) heroine Amphitrite (Sebring), who was sold privately as a broodmare prospect and exported to Japan after earning more than \$750,000 on the track. Amphitrite, a \$50,000 Magic Millions Adelaide Yearling Sale purchase, also had a Contrail (Deep Impact) filly sell for

¥56 million, approximately A\$494,000, at last week's JRHA Yearling Sale. Her dam Ocean Dream (Redoute's Choice) was covered by Tassort (Brazen Beau) last spring, while a Paulele (Dawn Approach) yearling filly from the family sold for \$120,000 at this year's Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale. Monroe Walk may now be set for the Shuka Sho (Gr 1, 2000m) for three year old fillies in October.

HKJC release new Season dates

The Hong Kong Jockey Club released the dates

for the 2026/2027 season which will commence on Sunday 6th September at Sha Tin. The season will again consist of 88 meetings, 40 during the day time, all bar one at Sha Tin and 41 night meetings of which 38 are at Happy Valley. Sha Tin will stage 7 twilight meeting late in the season which closes at Happy Valley on the 14th of July 2027. The new season will see former Godolphin Australia head trainer, James Cummings as the sole new addition to Hong Kong's training ranks.

Happy Valley novelty race predicts Spain's World Cup triumph

A Hong Kong Jockey Club promotion proved remarkably prophetic after Spain claimed the FIFA World Cup with a 1-0 extra-time victory over Argentina on Sunday. As part of the Club's "Racing With Football" series, Happy Valley staged the Eight To Glory race on July 8, with eight runners representing the World Cup quarter-finalists through specially designed silks. Spain was represented by Forza Toro (Aclaim), who, under Joao Moreira, surged clear to score by three lengths. The result attracted widespread attention following Spain's World Cup success on Sunday, having also matched EA SPORTS FC's pre-tournament simulation, which predicted Spain would lift the trophy.



International

Cup option for Trustyourinstinct, Al Riffa third

Trustyourinstinct (Churchill) emerged as a potential Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) contender after winning Sunday's Curragh Cup (Gr 2, 2800m). The Joseph O'Brien-trained six-year-old swept down the outside to defeat Happy Pharoah by three-quarters of a length, with Australian Bloodstock-owned favourite Al Riffa (Wootton Bassett) finishing third. "I'd say he'll come back to every Group race he can run in at the Curragh, and the Irish St Leger would be one of them, absolutely" O'Brien said, "Potentially he could go to the Melbourne Cup. It'll be an option for him for sure." Owned by JP McManus, Trustyourinstinct is a four-time stakes winner and has also won over hurdles. McManus also owns last year's Melbourne Cup runner-up Goodie Two Shoes (Fastnet Rock). O'Brien, who won the Melbourne Cup with Rekindling (High Chaparral) and Twilight Payment (Teofilo), said Al Riffa endured a luckless passage and suggested we see the best of him later in the Autumn.

Luster dominates Woodbine Oaks

Luster (Knicks Go) justified favouritism with a commanding 5.5-length victory in the Woodbine Oaks (9f) on Sunday. Ridden by John Velazquez for trainer Josie Carroll, the three-year-old stalked the pace before drawing clear of Dixie Law, with Bold Time third. The win was Velazquez's second consecutive Woodbine Oaks success and Carroll's fourth. An Ontario-bred, Luster was purchased for US\$80,000 at the 2024 Keeneland September Yearling Sale and entered the race following victory in the Selene Stakes (Gr 3, 8.5f). She has now won four of her five starts and earned US\$493,490. Carroll said Luster could potentially tackle male opposition in the King's Plate, the opening leg of Canada's Triple Crown.

Astern's G T Five Hundred springs Connaught Cup upset

G T Five Hundred (Astern) caused a 31-1 upset in the Connaught Cup Stakes (Gr 2, 7.5f) at Woodbine on Sunday. It was the third stakes win for the Dale Desruisseaux trained six-year-old which settled behind leader Maycocks Bay (Speightstown) before taking control inside the final furlong and defeating Irish Aces (Mshawish) by half a length. Maycocks Bay held third. G T Five Hundred stopped the clock at 1:28.64, recording his second win from four starts since being purchased privately by Centennial Farms and transferred from Mike Maker's US stable to Canada. Bred in Kentucky by Joe, John and Karen Mulholland, the gelding is out of winning Mineshaft (A P Indy) mare Cocoanut Row. Former Darley shuttler, Astern (Medaglia D'oro) shuttled for four seasons to Darley Lexington and was sold in late 2024 to continue his stallion career in Turkey.

Kiwi Chronicles

Change as good as a rest

Scouring Gavelhouse for tried racehorses with a view to finding improvement is not for the faint-hearted. As on-line sales grow in popularity, the number of bargain buys will naturally increase, the most recent Thebudgiesmugla (Redwood) who realised just \$3000 when he was sold as an untried 3YO gelding.

Foxton trainer Suzy Gordon is proving that change is as good as a rest, providing such for her August 2024 Gavelhouse purchase of Prioress (Proisir) for \$7250. At that time the mare had just turned six with a record of four wins, two of which took place at Trentham but her last win was more than a year prior to the sale. Many would look at that record and come to the conclusion that Prioress's level had been reached. Next stop: the breeding barn.

"I have had a lot of luck out of these second-hand horses off Gavelhouse," claims Gordon, referring to similar purchases. However, taking Prioress from winner to Listed winner is surely no accident. Gordon's record is apparent. Prioress is not her first experiment but by far her most successful.

Gordon tried the mare nine times as a 6YO for five placings. Even without winning, the experiment was a success as Prioress banked a smidge less than \$32,000. A further ten starts this season has brought three wins and additional \$122,000 in earnings, the mare's grand total reaching \$300,000.

"She only ever does what she has to," says Gordon. "It quite often looks like she has just fallen in, but that is her, she hits the front and pulls up."

Perhaps those words were ringing in the ears of rider Masa Hashizume because in Saturday's Cup he waited until the last possible moment to grab the precious win. Prioress shared third last at the 800m before Hashizume set her alight from the 600m. She was widest into the straight but her chances looked forlorn. Inside the 200m she gained but still had many lengths to make up. Over the final 100m she ground away and caught the leaders very late to win by a neck. "On the corner I thought I was going to run in the top three and every time I asked her she gave more and more," said Hashizume.

For Gordon, Prioress is her first stakes winner, made all the more special as she also saddled up second placed Turn The Ace (Turn Me Loose), another Gavelhouse purchase. "I'm a bit speechless as that is my first stakes winner.

They were both really well and I knew Prioress loves racing on the back-up, so I was happy with both of them", said Gordon.

The win put an exclamation mark against a second New Zealand Sire Premiership for Rich Hill Stud's Proisir (Choisir) who has now sired 25 individual stakes winners. That number is bound to increase as the quality of mares he attracts has similarly improved.

On the other side of the Tasman, Le Troisir (Proisir), a 4YO trained by Chris Waller, won a Benchmark 78 at Rosehill on Saturday. Underlining the stallion's versatility, Le Troisir's third career win from 15 starts was over 2400m.

Prioress may have done enough to warrant retirement now. Landing a Listed win would certainly be a nice way to go out. Her foals will be in demand and she represents a sound family. Her dam, Listed placed Shahbab (Bertolini),

was successful on six occasions. The sires of her grandam, third dam and fourth dam were all champions, namely Zabeel (Sir Tristram), Imposing (Todman) and Summertime (Precipitation). All the right blood is there.

She is a direct descendant of Desert Gold Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m) winner Ruelle (Summertime) who was discussed here after another relative, Sterling Express (Shamexpress), took out the Foxbridge Plate (Gr 2, 1200m) last August. Sterling Express's fourth dam is a half-sister to Prioress's third dam. The most accomplished descendant is Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) St Covet (Covetous). A further generation removed reveals that Ruelle's dam Ruve (Oman) and the dam of dual Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) winner Think Big (Sobig), namely Sarcelle (Oman), are sisters.

What about Foxbridge?

A week ago, Kiwi Chronicles called Proisir (Choisir) New Zealand Champion Sire for 2025-26. Not exactly a bold call. His earnings lead over the late, great Savabeel (Zabeel) was insurmountable.

A week later and Proisir affirmed his position, to claim a second Grosvenor Award after a gritty win from Prioress (Proisir) in Saturday's Opukake Cup (Listed, 1400m). Bagging a second New Zealand title is proof that the stallion is no one hit wonder. Between Proisir and Savabeel, they have been one and two the last four seasons.

As for making calls, it might not be wise to write off a Savabeel comeback for the 2027 season. If so, Savabeel would equal Foxbridge (Foxlaw) and his 11 titles, the only difference being that Foxbridge's were in succession.

This segway to Foxbridge is not accidental. The writer notes that three stallion awards are up for grabs annually and are to be presented by the NZTBA this coming Saturday in Cambridge. The Grosvenor Award recognises the leading sire based on New Zealand earnings. The Dewar Award recognises the New Zealand-based stallion with the highest Australasian earnings while the Centaine Award extends to world-wide earnings.

If the New Zealand Thoroughbred Breeders' Association is reading this, is it time to annually recognise the Champion Broodmare Sire? It

might carry the name: The Foxbridge Award, after the stallion who headed the category on 11 occasions.

O'Reilly (Last Tycoon) is currently in control of that territory including this season and has been the Champion Broodmare Sire now for five successive seasons. Lurking is Savabeel who was runner-up to his former barn mate in 2025 as well as this season. What odds would the TAB offer re Savabeel topping both championships for 2027?

Going one better

After Proisir gains his second Grosvenor Award at this week's awards, it will be Little Avondale Stud's turn to reflect on deserved recognition for Per Incanto (Street Cry) who will snare both the Dewar and Centaine Awards. This will be his second Centaine title but in adding the Dewar Award has gone one better due to his outstanding big-time earners Jimmysstar and Gringotts. Per Incanto has broken the stranglehold that Savabeel has enjoyed as Dewar Award champion for nine of the past ten years.

As the leading New Zealand-based sire in Australia Per Incanto has amassed close to \$15 million in earnings this term. It appears he will finish sixth against the best of the Australians and is far ahead of the next two New Zealand sires Savabeel (Zabeel) and Shamexpress (O'Reilly) who sit 29th and 30th respectively.

His position is all the more impressive when you consider that he had just 94 runners in Australia in the current season. The other nine of the top ten Australian sires averaged 278 runners. Saturday saw two metropolitan winners for Per Incanto.

Little Avondale will no doubt be very interested in Prima Bella who had to share her Flemington Benchmark 78 win, her career sixth in just 13 starts. The 5YO mare also won at Randwick this past May. Little Avondale Stud bred and sold Prima Bella from a family that has been a major part of the great Te Parae/Little Avondale story, going back to a yearling bred by Sam Williams' grandmother, Nancy Williams, in 1941.

At Rosehill, Rolling Magic, from the same crop as Prima Bella, also scored his sixth win, at Benchmark 72 level. Saturday's victory was

Rolling Magic's second at Rosehill and he has earned \$357,000, a good return on the \$100,000 outlaid for him at the 2022 Melbourne Wm Inglis Premier Sale. He is a grandson of 2018 NZ Broodmare of the Year Bagalollias (Zabeel), dam of brother and sister Group 1 winners Werther (Tavistock) and Toffee Tongue (Tavistock).

Winter tests

When the going gets tough, the tough get going. This old saying has never been truer than lately with the spate of winter staying tests taken out by some tough Kiwis including Asterix (Tavistock) and Thebudgiesmugla (Redwood). Add to them King Pedro (Eminent), who raced in New Zealand as Don Pedro before his sale to Australian interests.

In nabbing the Grafton Cup (Listed, 2350m), King Pedro certainly didn't make it look easy. Turning for home he had one behind him, was pulled out into the centre of the track then made a sustained run to get up in the last stride. The win provided the first stakes winner for Brighthill Stud's Eminent (Frankel) and as suggested in the 30th June edition of Kiwi Chronicles, Eminent's stock prefer the longer journeys.

The best performer in his close up family is his grandam's half-sister Miss Marielle (Encosta De Lago), a high class mare who bagged Rosehill's Hill Stakes (Gr 2, 1900m) among six wins in total. Miss Marielle excelled in the breeding barn, producing Coolmore Classic (Gr 1, 1500m) winner Peeping (Redoute's Choice) while Miss Marielle's half-brother Eurozone (Northern Meteor) was successful at Group 2 level.
