The Breeding Barn can wait

The words 'unsung hero' can be attributed to a number of different unseen participants in the horse racing industry, but one that definitely fits the bill is the job of a farrier, and none more so in the incredible case of Spicy Martini (Justify) and Scott Bryce.

Bryce, a professional farrier that is now based in Queensland but who frequently travels for special cases, is directly tied to the recent huge success of Toby Edmonds' mare - who landed the Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1400m) when last seen on June 13.

Spicy Martini is a four-year-old daughter of Justify (Scat Daddy) that was purchased by Edmonds for a mere \$8,000 during the 2023 Inglis March (Early) Online Sale out of Coolmore Stud, a price that on first looks makes you question 'how was she so cheap?'

However, along with Spicy Martini's undoubtedly elite-level talent comes an ongoing problem with her feet, a problem that Bryce has long dealt with first hand.

The mare has 'chronic heel pain' according to Bryce, meaning the process of shoeing her and keeping her feet sound during her racing campaigns is an arduous one, but one that has ultimately reaped great rewards.

Entries open for Magic Millions' 2027 yearling sales

Magic Millions has opened entries for its 2027 series of yearling sales, which will feature auctions across Queensland, Tasmania, Western Australia and South Australia between January and March.

The selling season will commence with the flagship Gold Coast Yearling Sale from January 12 to 17, followed by the Tasmanian Yearling Sale on February 15 and the Perth Yearling Sale on February 18 and 19.

The Adelaide Yearling Sale will be held on March 14 and 15, before the Gold Coast March Yearling Sale concludes the series on March 22 and 23.

Continued from page 1 “She gets chronic heel pain, it’s due to her confirmation,” Bryce told ANZ News. “She trots like a duck and swings her legs here and everywhere, but she’s obviously well worth all the effort.

“She would be one of the worst-footed horses I have ever worked on and it’s such a big process to keep her sound while she’s in racing work.

“She is quite a funny horse as when she’s not comfortable she can go from a 4 out of 5 lame to spot on once you find the right thing for her. She’s a lovely patient though and very well behaved.”

Bryce reveals that the task of getting her shoes correct to withstand her racing work is one that has taken hours of trial and error and practice.

“It’s about a four-hour process to shoe her, we do lots of different things,” he says.

“We have to get her ankles right, take videos of how she’s landing and make sure she’s loading evenly on certain parts, so it’s a long process.

“There’s been times we’ve tried like seven different things until we’ve found the right one that works for her.”

Adding to complications last preparation, Spicy Martini had actually developed a kind

of quarter crack in one foot prior to her career-high Group 1 success last month, meaning plenty of work was done beforehand to have the mare in racing condition.

“So she had a bad overreach which then developed into a quarter crack so we had to dremel down that crack and then with a drill bit we drilled through the foot and stitched it all together with quartet crack lines,” Bryce revealed.

“She actually won the Stradbroke with that all stitched up.”

Edmonds, who is based on the Gold Coast, had employed other farriers in an attempt to fix Spicy Martini’s feet ailments before he came across Bryce – who reveals he was recommended to the trainer by expert equine veterinarian Dr. Johnnie Walker.

“They had multiple farriers in to work on her but they couldn’t keep her sound and it was Johnnie Walker that recommended me to Toby to fly me up to Queensland,” Bryce said.

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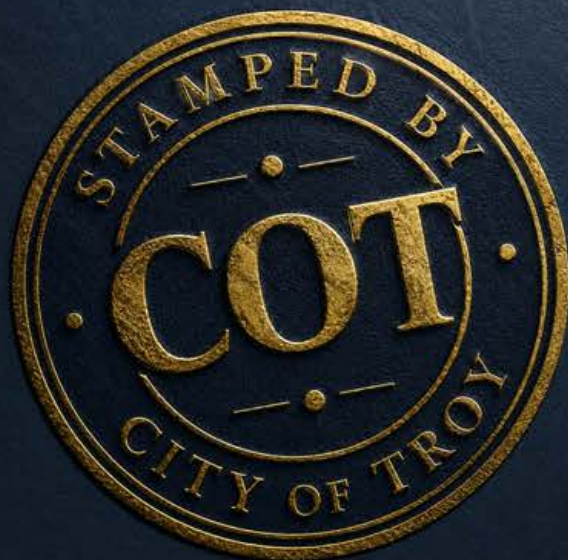

Continued from page 2 “There’s been nights that we’ve been there for five hours! Before she won the Ascot Handicap [on April 18] she was lame as a cat so we stayed there on the Wednesday night and worked there for five and a half hours, myself and Toby, and we got her sound and she’s been as good as gold ever since.

“We finally worked out the solution for her and the confirmation in her feet and she’s been airborne ever since then.”

The word ‘airborne’ is absolutely the correct way to describe Spicy Martini’s trajectory over the last three months. A trajectory that could have been towards the breeding barn instead of Group 1 glory and leading contender for this Springs key sprints.

As a dual Listed scorer and winner of the Fred Best Classic (Gr 3, 1350m), a three-year-old Spicy Martini took to the Stradbroke Handicap in June, 2025 but could only manage 15th of the 18 runners that day as a \$51 poke.

Fast forward two stints in the spelling paddock and a pair of midfield runs in the

Sheraco Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) and Silver Eagle (1300m), the mare was hitting the front again in the Ascot Handicap (Listed, 1000m) back in April this year.

However, it was two starts ago that her form really hit new levels with a second placing, beaten a length, behind the evergreen Rothfire (Rothsay) in May’s Doomben 10,000 (Gr 1, 1200m), teeing her up beautifully for her last-start Stradbroke success – at the second attempt.

Since then, the mare has again visited the spelling paddock, although only for a short period prior to her upcoming spring campaign, something that again brings about a different scenario for Bryce.

“She’s only having four weeks out, if we tipped her out barefoot then her feet would all break away and because she’s got such bad feet she doesn’t really cope without shoes,” he said.

“So we took all the special stuff off [after her race] and hot shod her up and she goes out like that.

“When she’s in actual training work we have heel rebuilds on her, special bar plates, pads, and at some points we’ve had to fix her feet up and keep her foot together.

“I rebuild her feet, I handmade special bar shoes for her and all sorts of stuff. So I rebuild the heel and change her angles to redistribute the weight over the whole foot.

“When you rebuild the heel, none of the pressure is actually going up the real heel, it goes up the fake one you’ve built which alleviates the actual heel.

“So I go to the races with her and change her over to racing plates in the tie-up stalls out the back before she goes out, and then usually we put the bars back on after the race but after the Stradbroke we knew she was heading for a spell so we didn’t do that.”

What really makes Spicy Martini even more unique is the fact that in every other sense she is sound, with Bryce admitting it is just the mare’s feet that cause her any problems.

"It is solely her feet," he said. "You can ask the owners as the vet hasn't had to go anywhere near her!"

"They're pretty lucky to be honest given her conformation. A good conformation on a horse is where you'd run a plumb line down its knee and it should drop at the centre of its foot, with her you run a centre line down her knee and you get thin air underneath, there is no foot there."

"So you can understand why she only got sold for \$8,000, which is a miracle, given what they paid for her, how she's turned out."

"This prep is the soundest we've had her and it seems we've finally worked out the right package for her."

Spicy Martini now incredibly finds herself as a genuine Group 1 winner and hugely valuable broodmare prospect instead of potentially being lightly raced or retired, largely in part to the work of Bryce. Trainer Toby Edmonds was quick to give credit to his farrier as the mare returned to the mounting yard

on Stradbroke Day and winning jockey Taylor Marshall also rang to give his thanks after the mare's Stradbroke victory.

"Not many people really realise what goes into keeping a horse like her sound," he said, while showing support for his many farrier counterparts and Edmonds stable team.

"The hundreds of hours that we've spent on her and multiple nights being there just to keep her going. Plenty would have no idea what goes into this stuff."

As for what is next for Spicy Martini, Edmonds revealed that a trip to Randwick for The Shorts (Gr 2, 1100m) on September 19 is the first-up plan, and considering the mountain already climbed to unlock her potential, a tilt at The Everest seems well within her ability.

"She'll head to Sydney for the spring and her kick-off point will be The Shorts on September 19," Edmonds told ANZ.

"She has spelled extremely well and was back in work last Friday."

Dual Group placegetter Eviction Notice (Stay Inside) will chase his maiden victory in Saturday's Marcellin College Randwick Handicap (1100m), with The Rosebud (Listed, 1100m) a potential next target. The Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott-trained gelding placed in the Canonbury Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) and Silver Slipper Stakes (Gr 2, 1100m) during the autumn before finishing midfield behind subsequent Golden Slipper (Gr 1, 1200m) placegetter Music Time (All Too Hard) in the Black Opal Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m). Eviction Notice was gelded whilst out and resumed with a second to Castillo King (Farnan) at Warwick Farm earlier this month.

King Of Pop back after throat surgery

Black Opal Stakes winner King Of Pop (Farnan) will make his first appearance since undergoing tie-back surgery in Saturday's Elite Sand and Soil Handicap (1100m) at Randwick. The Sterling Alexiou and Gerald Ryan-trained gelding gained a start following the scratching of Salsa Fellow (Blue Point). King Of Pop failed to recapture his juvenile form last spring and again disappointed when fifth in the Sunlight Consolation (1100m) at the Gold Coast in January when last seen.

Big Dance (Listed, 1600m) placegetter Lugh (Snitzel) will return to 1600 metres in Saturday's ATC Thank You Trainers Handicap (1600m) at Randwick as he attempts to end the season with a sixth career victory. The Ciaron Maher-trained gelding finished third behind stablemates Gringotts (Per Incanto) and Vivvy Air (Hellbent) in last year's Big Dance and has resumed with placings over 1300 and 1400 metres. Connections are hoping to qualify Lugh for either the Big Dance or Little Dance (1600m) during the spring.

Maher pair launch spring campaigns at Caulfield

Promising Ciaron Maher-trained pair Ghana's Akan (Street Boss) and Milsons Point (Blue Point) will begin their spring campaigns in Saturday's Stow Robotics Handicap (1100m) at Caulfield. Milsons Point has been gelded since finishing unplaced in the VOBIS Platinum Showdown (1200m) in March and has completed two jump-outs ahead of his return. The Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) shapes as a possible long-term target, with the Mike Moroney Stakes (Listed, 1400m), Caulfield Guineas Prelude (Gr 3, 1400m) and Stutt Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m) among his potential lead-up races. Ghana's Akan remains a maiden after four starts but earned almost \$470,000 during her juvenile season, headed by a second in the Inglis Millennium (RL, 1100m) and fifth in the Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m). Jabez Johnstone's three-kilogram claim will reduce her 59-kilogram impost, with the Quezette Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) a possible target.

Blinkers added to Prince Tycoon

Prince Tycoon (Written Tycoon) will wear blinkers for the first time when he contests Saturday's Quayclean Handicap (1100m) at Caulfield. The Trent Busuttin and Natalie Young-trained gelding has shown considerable ability winning on debut at Caulfield before finishing runner-up in the Magic Millions National 2YO Classic (1000m) at the Gold Coast. He resumed this preparation with victory at Bendigo and has since placed twice in Melbourne, most recently finishing a narrow second to Wise Inlaw (Wootton Bassett) in the AR Creswick Stakes (Listed, 1200m) at Flemington. Prince Tycoon had also been frustrating with his antics at the barriers which resulted in him spending time with Julien Welsh. Young said that 'education' had resulted in better efforts this campaign.

Silent Thinker chasing consecutive wins

Matthew Dunn's Silent Thinker (So You Think) is chasing consecutive wins at Ipswich on Friday. Purchased for \$50,000 through the Inglis December Online Sale by Neil Jenkinson and Viva Racing, the lightly raced three-year-old will have his third start over 1350 metres having broken his maiden with an all-the-way victory at the track over 1200 metres earlier this month. That success followed a debut third at the Gold Coast at 1300 metres. Dunn expects the gelding to improve to metropolitan company as he steps up in distance.

Spring stars set for Rosehill trials

Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) winner Green Spaces (Street Boss), Queen Of The Turf Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) heroine Idle Flyer (Dundeel) and Flight Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Apocalyptic (Extreme Choice) headline Friday's barrier trials at Rosehill. The Group 1-winning trio will clash with Savvy Hallie (Hellbent) in the opening 900-metre Group trial. The Brad Widdup-trained Savvy Hallie narrowly finished runner-up to Tempted (Street Boss) in the Surround Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) before ending her autumn campaign with an unplaced effort against older mares in the Coolmore Classic (Gr

1, 1500m). Savvy Hallie is expected to resume in either the Toy Show Quality (Gr 3, 1100m) or Show County Quality (Gr 3, 1200m) at Randwick on August 22. Stablemate Jedibeel (Savabeel) is recovering well from throat surgery following his run in The Quokka (1200m) and could return late in the spring. Canonbury Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) winner Hidrix (Extreme Choice) and Widden Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) heroine Chilly Girl (Trapeze Artist) are also scheduled to trial.

Currie links with new manager

Luke Currie has appointed a new manager as he looks to rebuild following a recent holiday. Currie rode French Accord (Kermadec) to victory at Sandown on Wednesday and has two mounts at Caulfield on Saturday, headed by Winnasedge (Cliffs Edge) in the Bletchingly Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m). The jockey partnered the Nick Ryan-trained sprinter to victory in the Sir John Monash Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) at Caulfield on July 11, his second meeting back in the saddle.

Waterhouse and Bott secure Leilani Lodge lease

The Australian Turf Club (ATC) has granted Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott a lease for 65 boxes at the former Leilani Lodge stables at Randwick. Vacated in early 2025 after Anthony Cummings had his training licence revoked, Ciaron Maher was then successful in a tender process with Maher subsequently relinquishing the lease after securing Crown Lodge at Warwick Farm. The High Street facility has undergone significant remediation works to bring it up to modern standards. The additional on-course stabling will allow the partnership to consolidate its Randwick operation and reduce horse movements from its main Tulloch Lodge base along Bowral Street and Doncaster Avenue. ATC chief executive Steve McMahon said the move would improve safety around the precinct and eventually ensure horses no longer needed to cross public roads for morning trackwork or afternoon exercise.

Freedman picks up Randwick boxes

The ATC has made 20 boxes available at Royal Randwick for trainer Michael Freedman, who

was the other short-listed applicant for the Leilani Lodge stables. Freedman has trained 109 winners nationally, including 62 in NSW for the season.

Queensland racing governance model remains under review

Queensland Racing minister Tim Mander has conceded the state's proposed hybrid racing governance model remains a work in progress following the resignation of respected integrity official Kim Kelly. Kelly, a former Hong Kong chief steward, recently quit as Queensland Racing Integrity Commission (QRIC) deputy commissioner over concerns the new structure would compromise the body's independence. During a Queensland Parliament estimates hearing on Thursday, shadow racing minister Grace Grace said Kelly's departure had sent shockwaves through the industry. Mander expressed regret over Kelly's resignation but said the Queensland Government remained committed to introducing a new governance framework. However, the minister was unable to confirm the final structure or how responsibilities would be divided between QRIC and Racing Queensland.

Equimillion nominations open

Nominations have opened for Equimillion 2026, Australia's richest equestrian event dedicated to retired thoroughbred racehorses. Now entering its fourth year, the event will be held at the Sydney International Equestrian Centre in October, with riders from across Australia competing for more than \$1 million in prize-money. Further information and nominations are available on the Equimillion website.

Tsoi dispersal marks end of an era

More than 25 years of Australasian breeding and racing under Dr Gene Tsoi's distinctive violet-and-pink colours will conclude with the Standard 2080 Ltd Unreserved Dispersal Sale on Gavelhouse Plus. A total of 13 horses

from the Hong Kong-based physician's New Zealand portfolio will be offered without reserve, featuring families developed through Hong Kong Derby winner Elegant Fashion (Danewin) and multiple Group 1 winner King's Rose (Redoute's Choice). Dr Tsoi enjoyed a long association with the late Sir Patrick Hogan and Cambridge Stud, while also supporting operations including Bhima Thoroughbreds, Maluka Thoroughbreds, Kiltannon and Carlaw Park. Former Cambridge Stud manager Marcus Corban is handling the dispersal, which includes yearling fillies by Maurice (Screen Hero) and Satono Aladdin (Deep Impact), a weanling colt by Almanzor (Wootton Bassett) and young stock by Super Seth (Dundeel). The broodmares are in foal to stallions including Auguste Rodin (Deep Impact), Armory (Galileo), Super Seth, Hello Youmzain (Kodiac), Circus Maximus (Galileo) and Sword Of State (Snitzel). Bidding is open and closes from 7pm NZT on Thursday, July 30.

NZB graduates celebrated after Group 1 season

New Zealand Bloodstock graduates recorded another strong season at the highest level in 2025-26, winning eight Group 1 races in Australia and five in New Zealand. The 13 elite-level victories were recorded by ten individual NZB graduates over distances ranging from 1200 to 2500 metres. The ten Group 1-winning Karaka graduates were purchased for an average of \$98,400. Aeliana (Castelvecchio) was the most expensive at \$180,000, while Mr Brightside (Bullbars) and Globe (Charm Spirit) were secured for \$22,000 each and Wigmore (Sweynesse) cost \$25,000. More than 20 New Zealand-bred Group 1 winners will be celebrated by the New Zealand Thoroughbred Breeders' Association at the Don Rowlands Centre at Lake Karapiro on Saturday, July 25.

MYS: Choice Is Mine chasing Selangor Mile riches

Unbeaten galloper Choice Is Mine (Turn Me Loose) will attempt to extend his winning sequence in Sunday's RM1 million (approx. AU\$350,000) Selangor Mile (1600m) at Kuala

Lumpur. The four-year-old won on debut in New Zealand in February last year before returning from a 15-month absence with a three-length victory over Navarre (Written Tycoon) in a 1400-metre Max Two contest on May 17. Choice Is Mine followed that performance with another success in the same grade four weeks later, scoring by 1.25 lengths. With several leading contenders drawn wide, Choice Is Mine appears well served in barrier five as he steps up to 1600 metres.

MYS: Fortune Rising chasing fourth Malaysian win

Fortune Rising (Alabama Express) will attempt to extend his unbeaten Malaysian record in Sunday's Selangor Silver (1300m) at Kuala Lumpur. The HY Cheng-trained four-year-old arrived from Australia after producing several encouraging performances in stakes company under the name Shangri La Express and has since won all three local starts. Fortune Rising resumed from a three-and-a-half-month break with a dominant 4.25-length Class 2 victory a fortnight ago, providing apprentice WH Lim with his first winner.



International

13 for Ghaiyyath

Darley shuttler Ghaiyyath (Dubawi) sired his 13th individual stakes winner on Thursday when the Richard Hannon-trained Aperoll (2 f ex Rue Cambon by Exceed And Excel) made all for a narrow success in the Star Stakes (Listed, 7f) at Sandown. Ridden by Pat Dobbs, the filly broke well from her outside draw and went from pillar-to-post, always holding on at the finish from late challenger Bayside View (Bayside Boy) to win by a neck. There was a

further length and a half back to Tall Trees (Showcasing) in third. Bred by Plantation Stud, Aperoll was purchased for 80,000gns by Peter and Ross Doyle Bloodstock during Book 2 of the 2025 Tattersalls October Yearling Sale and is raced by Johnny de la Hey. A half-sister to winner Alexis Zorba (Zoustar), she is the fifth foal out of the Exceed And Excel (Danehill) mare Rue Cambon, herself a sister to Group 2 winner Royal Intervention and a half-sister to Grade 1 scorer Gorella (Grape Tree Road) and Listed winner Porto Santo (Kingsalsa). Ghaiyyath, who currently sits fourth in the Australian Second Season Sires' title, has returned to Darley's Northwood Park base for the 2026 breeding season at a fee of \$88,000 (inc GST).

34 for Havana Grey

Big Negotiator (2 f ex Star Spirit by Deep Impact) became the 34th individual stakes winner for Whitsbury Manor Stud stallion Havana Grey (Havana Gold) when taking out Wednesday's Marwell Stakes (Listed, 5f) at Naas. Ridden by Wayne Lordan, the Paddy Twomey-trained filly made virtually all and kept on well inside the closing stages to beat Shimmering Sun by one and a quarter lengths in a one-two for the stallion. There was a further two and a half lengths back to Belle Of The Ball (Mohaather) in third. Bred by Lady Bamford, Big Negotiator was a 30,000gns purchase by Connor King at the 2025 Tattersalls December Yearling Sale and races in the silks of Bond Thoroughbred Limited. She is a half-sister to Italian Listed winner Star Of Life (Starspangledbanner) being the second foal out of the Deep Impact (Sunday Silence) mare Star Spirit, herself out of Prix de Diane (Gr 1, 2100m) winner Star Of Seville (Duke Of Marmalade). Havana Grey stood the 2026 northern hemisphere breeding season for a private fee.

95 for Siyouni

Haras de Bonneval stalwart Siyouni (Pivotal) chalked up his 95th individual stakes winner on Wednesday when Algebre (2 c ex Soustraction by Lope De Vega) scored in the Prix des Jouvenceaux & Jouvencelles - Bernard Ferrand (Listed, 1400m) at Vichy. The Christopher Head-trained colt was ridden by Maxime Guyon and defeated Skyridge (Goken) by a length and a half, with the same distance further back to Palais Byzantin (Galiway) in third place. Bred and raced by Wertheimer Et Frere, Algebre is a half-brother to winners Arithmetique (Anodin), Creatif (Dubawi) and Mature (Zarak) being out of the Group 3-winning Lope De Vega (Shamardal) mare Soustraction. Siyouni stood the 2026 northern hemisphere breeding season at a fee of €150,000 (approx. AU\$244,620).

UK: Masquerade Ball primed for Calandagan rematch

Japanese star Masquerade Ball (Duramente) will renew his rivalry with Calandagan (Gleneagles) in Saturday's King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Stakes (Gr 1, 1m 4f) at Ascot. The Takahisa Tezuka-trained four-year-old finished a head behind the French champion in last year's Japan Cup (Gr 1, 2400m), having previously won the Tenno Sho Autumn (Gr 1, 2000m). Masquerade Ball has been based at James Horton's Newmarket stable after travelling to Britain via Alaska and Amsterdam, with Tezuka pleased by his physical and mental development. "He's progressed a lot from three to four," Tezuka said. "I've a feeling he is still hiding another gear." Masquerade Ball was last seen finishing runner-up to Romantic Warrior (Acclamation) in the Queen Elizabeth II Cup (Gr 1, 2000m) in Hong Kong in April. Calandagan will attempt to win the King George for a second consecutive year.

IRE: Tattersalls Ireland announces Hungarian sponsorship

Tattersalls Ireland will sponsor a race in Hungary for the first time when the Tattersalls Ireland-Overdose Race is staged at Kincsem Park in Budapest on September 6. The race will form part of one of Hungary's leading international race days and is named in honour of Overdose (Starborough), the celebrated Hungarian sprinter who established himself among Europe's leading speedsters. Hungarian Thoroughbred Owners' Association president Bodorics István welcomed the expansion of Tattersalls' support for the country's racing industry. "We look forward to welcoming the Tattersalls Ireland team to Kincsem Park in early September," he said. The catalogue for the Tattersalls Ireland September Yearling Sale is scheduled to be released at the end of July.

US: Bloodstock agent Bill Reightler dies

Respected Maryland bloodstock agent and consignor Bill Reightler died on July 21 following a battle with pancreatic cancer. Reightler spent more than 45 years in the thoroughbred industry and founded Reightler Bloodstock in 1999, establishing the operation as a leading force in the Mid-Atlantic region. Earlier in his career, he worked across the training, broodmare and stallion divisions at Spendthrift Farm in Kentucky before returning to Maryland to manage Ross Valley Farm, now Marathon Farm, and Chanceland Farm. Among the leading horses sold through Reightler's consignments were Grade 1 winner and stallion Army Mule (Friesan Fire) and 2021 US Horse of the Year Knicks Go (Paynter).

The Tony and Calvin McEvoy-trained One Day At A Time (Bivouac) broke her maiden at the fifth time of asking on Wednesday when landing a 1000-metre contest at Sandown-Hillside.

Having run third in the Maribyrnong Trial Stakes (Listed, 1000m) on debut back in October, the juvenile daughter of Bivouac (Exceed And Excel) had since produced third and sixth placings at Eagle Farm and a fourth-placed effort in the Next Generation Sprinters Series Final (1200m) at Flemington prior to her maiden victory.

Ridden by Jye McNeil on Wednesday, the filly proved a length and a half too strong for Egyptian Dancer (Portland Sky) with a further 0.4 lengths back to the third-placed Fontalicious (Hanseatic).

"He's [Calvin McEvoy] has always had a good opinion of her," stable representative Mitch Whelan said.

"She's shown plenty. Obviously only half-a-length off them in the Maribyrnong Trial in the spring and she's going really well.

"It's nice to see her knock it off and Jye really deserves it as he comes in and works hard for

us a couple of mornings a week. I'm just really happy for him.

"She's always been a nice type. Probably still not a heap of horse there, but she's growing and she's going the right way. She's very correct and has a lovely action and does everything well.

"Hopefully she can be a player in the spring and we've got something to look forward to."

Bred by Rosemont Stud, One Day At A Time was purchased out of the stud by her trainers in conjunction with Damon Gabbedy's Belmont Bloodstock for \$270,000.

She is the second winner from three to race out of the Charge Forward (Red Ransom) mare Everyday Lady, herself a Listed winner who also finished fourth in the Robert Sangster Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m).

Everyday Lady is from the family of former Horse of the Year Weekend Hussler (Hussonet), Group 1 winner Lucky Hussler (Husson) as well as Group 3 scorers Phantom Thief (Harbinger) and Saturday Fever (Groom Dancer). She foaled a filly by Hanseatic (Street Boss) in the spring before being covered by Rosemont's Schwarz (Zoustar).

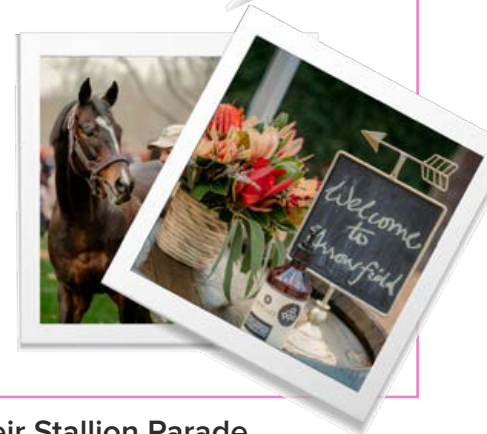
