New Zealand breeders rewarded after elite global season

Sir Brendan and Lady Jo Lindsay's Cambridge Stud was crowned New Zealand Breeder of the Year at the New Zealand Thoroughbred Breeders' Awards on Saturday night, heading a stellar list of winners recognised after another exceptional season for New Zealand breeders on the world stage.

Accepting the Sir Patrick and Lady Justine Hogan New Zealand Breeder of the Year Award, Sir Brendan reflected on the significance of receiving an honour bearing the names of

Cambridge Stud's former custodians.

"It's quite surreal, buying Cambridge Stud and this award being named after Sir Patrick and Lady Justine Hogan," Lindsay said.

"It's a long way away from buying my first horse, which I raced with Trevor McKee. I remember excitedly telling my father and there wasn't a huge amount of support.

"I think Ceolwulf was a real highlight as a breeder this season. John Foote bought the dam for €55,000 and she has gone on to leave an elite-level miler, and we sold a foal out of her for \$1.1 million this year, which is just incredible.

Dryden launches dual Forbes Cup bid

Canberra trainers Keith Dryden and Libby Snowden will launch a two-pronged attack on Sunday's Forbes Cup (1600m) with Missile Leader (Smart Missile) and Acheson (Churchill).

The \$50,000 feature is a qualifier for the \$3 million Big Dance at Randwick in November. Missile Leader heads to Forbes after a well-supported victory at Wagga, while Acheson was runner-up in the Narrandera Cup (1600m) at his latest start.

"Missile Leader is going along well and it's a nice race for him, while Acheson is entered at Kensington next Wednesday, but I think Forbes is the better option," Dryden told Racing NSW.

Cambridge Stud's season was headlined by Ceolwulf (Tavistock), winner of the King Charles III Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) and Champions Mile (Gr 1, 1600m), while the farm was also recognised as the breeder of Jaarffi (Iffraaj), winner of the Otaki-Maori WFA Classic (Gr 1, 1600m).

Cambridge Stud was chosen from a strong group of finalists that included Nearco Stud, Rich Hill Thoroughbreds and Waikato Stud. Nearco Stud and Rich Hill were represented by Aeliana (Castelvecchio), winner of the Ranvet Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) and Tancred Stakes (Gr 1, 2400m), while Rich Hill also bred She's A Dealer (Ace High), winner of the New Zealand Thoroughbred Breeders' Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m). Waikato Stud's season featured 15 black-type winners and 16 stakes-placed horses.

Sir Brendan also spoke warmly about the camaraderie within the thoroughbred industry, referencing a function held the previous day for respected racing administrator Butch Castles, who is facing health challenges.

"This industry is a great industry and when you are down, there are a lot of people who will help, and when you're up at the top, it gives everyone an opportunity to strive and get up there with you," he said.

While acknowledging the industry was going through a period of transition, Sir Brendan remained bullish about the future of New Zealand breeding.

"You can't ignore the fact that over the last five years, 21 per cent of the Group 1 winners in Australia have been bred in New Zealand," he said.

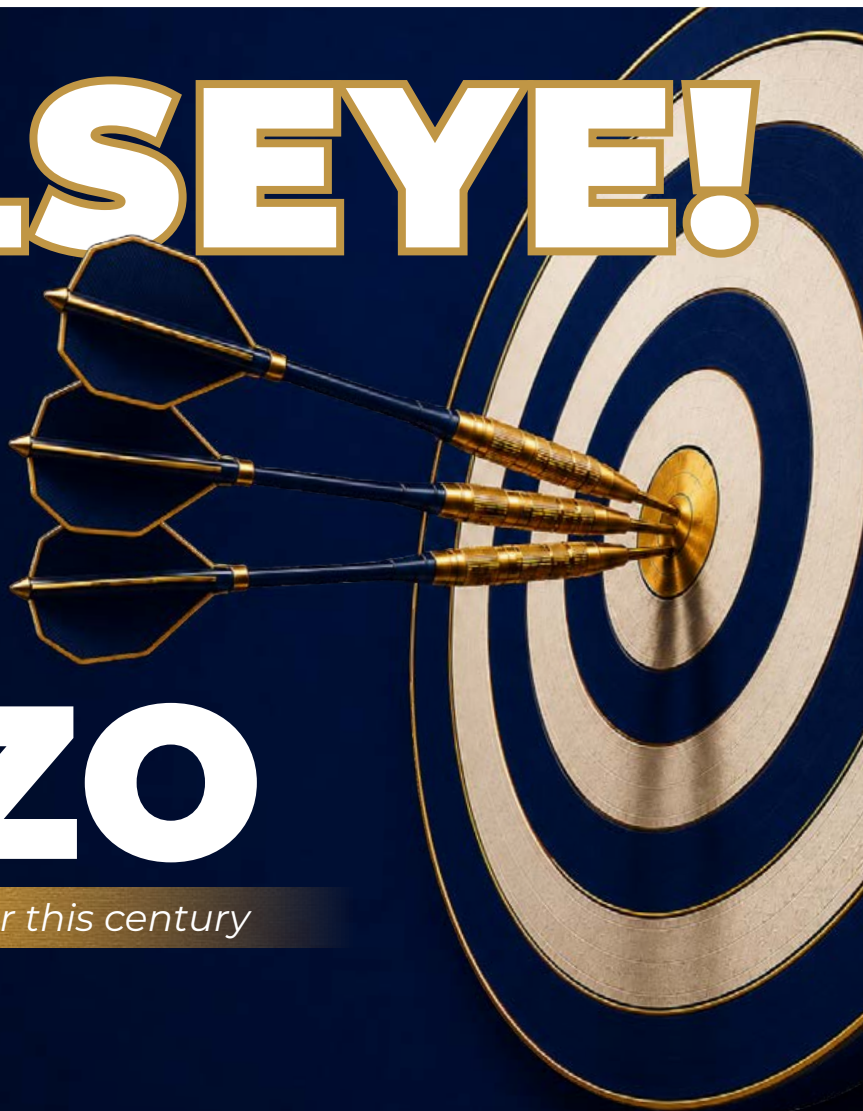
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Continued from page 2 “The opportunities for this country are just enormous. Unfortunately, there has been a drop in foal numbers, but that creates an opportunity because the industry needs stock, and for us at Cambridge Stud to be able to bring in stallions of international appeal like Chaldean and Charyn is just amazing.

“I get up every morning and look forward to the day. I try to make the day a new challenge, and I think this industry just has so much upside.”

The Property Brokers Seton Otway Horse of the Year title went to Ka Ying Rising (Shamexpress), whose extraordinary campaign established him as one of the world's elite racehorses.

Bred by Grandmoral Lodge, the champion sprinter remained unbeaten in eight starts during the season, winning five Group 1 races across Hong Kong and Australia, including becoming the first overseas-trained horse to capture The Everest (Gr 1, 1200m). He also successfully defended the

Hong Kong Sprint (Gr 1, 1200m), completed a second consecutive Hong Kong Speed Series and finished the season with a Hong Kong record 20 consecutive victories, while earning a rating as the joint-best racehorse in the world.

Ka Ying Rising's dam Missy Moo (Per Incanto) was named the Eight Carat Broodmare of the Year. A winning daughter of Per Incanto (Street Cry) who was previously trained by Fraser Auret, Missy Moo produced only two foals, headed by the champion son of Shamexpress (O'Reilly).

Grandmoral Lodge was chosen from a shortlist that also included the breeders of Romanoff (Belardo), Desert Lightning (Pride Of Dubai), Oak Hill (Per Incanto), Lollapalooza (El Roca) and War Princess (U S Navy Flag).

Per Incanto enjoyed the finest season of his career, claiming both the Centaine Award, presented to the leading sire by worldwide progeny earnings, and the Dewar Award,

recognising the leading sire by progeny earnings across New Zealand and Australia. His success in the Dewar Award ended the late Savabeel's remarkable run in the category.

Proisir (Choisir) claimed the Grosvenor Award, presented to New Zealand's leading sire by domestic progeny earnings, after another outstanding season led by dual Group 1 winners Legarto and Waitak.

Ohope Wins (Ocean Park), who completed the New Zealand Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m)-Australian Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) double, was recognised as NZB Filly of the Year, while Jess Greenfield received the Mary-Lynne Ryan Young Achiever Award.

One of the most warmly received moments of the night came when Windsor Park Stud principal Rodney Schick was named NZTBA Personality of the Year, sponsored by Entain AU & NZ, in recognition of his lifetime contribution to New Zealand's thoroughbred breeding industry.

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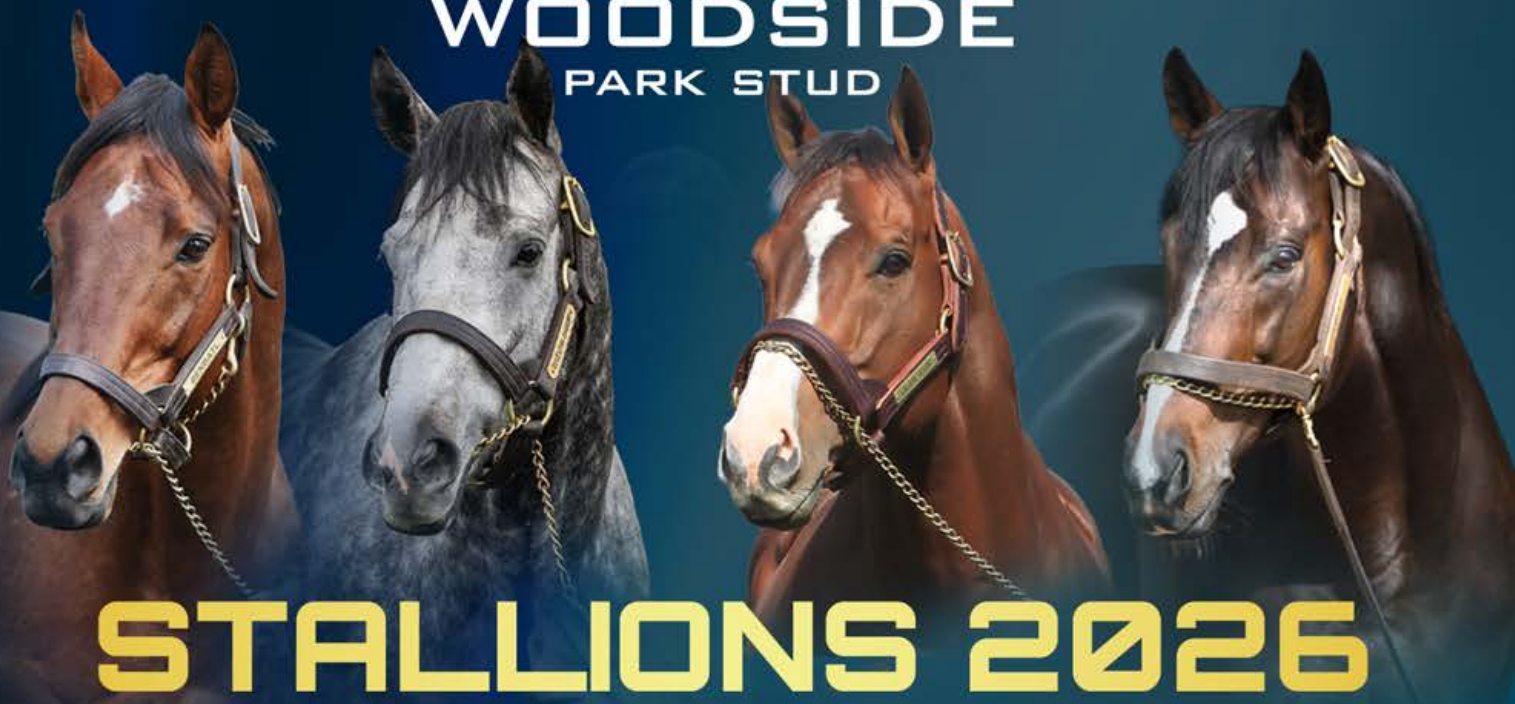

The award acknowledged Schick's achievements as a breeder and stud master, along with his leadership, generosity, mentorship and passion for helping the industry thrive.

"It's an absolute privilege to receive this award from your peers," an emotional Schick said as he accepted the honour alongside his son Oli.

"It's an industry that I love, and I have been part of for a long time."

Schick, who grew up at Windsor Park Stud after his parents Nelson and Sue established the Cambridge farm, paid tribute to his wife Gina and the Windsor Park team following a deeply difficult 18 months for the family.

"First you need a bloody good wife, and Gina has been the absolute backbone for me for all our married life, but especially over these past 18 months, she has been unbelievable, along with the team at the farm," he said.

"My parents taught me a long time ago to surround yourself with good people and

certainly we have that at Windsor Park. It's an absolute family.

"To all my team, who have supported us through this past year or so, they have been unbelievable. The farm probably ran better without me than with me."

Despite those challenges, Schick said Windsor Park remained firmly focused on the future.

"We are certainly not slowing down,"

Schick said. "We have a new farm that we are developing, which is exciting, and we have got plenty of young stallions coming through, including Savaglee, who is new this year and standing in partnership with Simms Davison at Mapperley Stud."

"We love the industry and see a bright future. There are certainly a few things we need to work on, and I think getting together is most important."

Autumn Boy set for spring return

Dual Group 1 winner Autumn Boy (The Autumn Sun) is on track for a spring return, with trainer Chris Waller believing the four-year-old can achieve what his sire never had the chance to. Unlike The Autumn Sun (Redoute's Choice), who retired to stud after his three-year-old season, Autumn Boy will continue racing and is being aimed towards the Winx Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Randwick next month. "We've got that opportunity with Autumn Boy. He's racing on at four and I'm excited about that," Waller said. The colt has not raced since finishing runner-up in the Doncaster Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) to Sheza Alibi (Saxon Warrior).

Rockabye Roxy (Written By) has finished second in all four starts for the stable and will seek a breakthrough win in the Showcase Maiden Plate (1600m), while Everido (Supido) is expected to improve second-up in the Ben Hall Bullet (1200m). Diamond Frost (Frosted), Showtime Maggie (Showtime) and Restless Spirit (Portland Sky) are also among the stable's nominations, with Dryden hopeful a firmer surface will suit several members of the team.

Just Like Liam chases third straight win

Veteran Albury trainer Garry Worsnop will chase a winning hat-trick with Just Like Liam (Magic Albert) at Monday's final Southern District Racing Association meeting of the season. The rising seven-year-old will contest the Benchmark 58 (1600m) after successive victories over the course and distance on Heavy tracks. Bred by Koorngal Stud and purchased for \$6,000, Just Like Liam has earned more than \$125,000 and has finished inside the top five at each of his past six starts. "He has never raced better and the mile and a wet track suit him," Worsnop told Racing NSW. Leading jockey Brodie Loy takes the ride, with Worsnop adding visors for the first time after pacifiers helped spark the gelding's recent improvement. The 75-year-old prepares four horses and said training continues to provide him with plenty of enjoyment. "For a small trainer like me it gives me an interest," he said. "I have been back training for 14 years and I love having a few horses in work." Worsnop will also saddle lightly raced three-year-old Corays Road (Sandbar), also bred by Koorngal Stud and purchased for \$9000, in the Maiden Plate (1500m), with the trainer expecting the step up in distance to suit.

Pendragon dies

Pendragon (Elnadim) has died at the age of 23. Trained by the late Bart Cummings and raced in the colours of Dato Tan Chin Nam, Pendragon spent a total of 15 seasons at stud, his last in 2022 before retiring to the care of Fiona Mylan at Brisbane Meadows on the Southern Highlands. Pendragon sired the winners of almost \$10 million including Group two winners Miss Gunpowder and Sky Boy.

Full brother to Kings Gambit wins on debut

Organised Crime (I Am Invincible), a full brother to Group 1-placed juvenile and young sire King's Gambit, made an impressive winning debut at Sale on Sunday. Prepared by Lloyd Kennewell, the two-year-old justified favouritism in the 1000-metre maiden, taking over inside the final furlong before scoring by three-quarters of a length under Jye McNeil. A \$350,000 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale purchase, Organised Crime became the 11th two-year-old winner this season for champion sire I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit) and is the fourth winner from Group 3-winning mare Sultry Feeling (Encosta De Lago).

Stern Idol to retire

Champion jumper Stern Idol (Raven's Pass) will make the final start of his decorated career when he bids for a fourth Crisp Steeplechase (4200m) at Sandown next Sunday.

Trainer Ciaron Maher confirmed the nine-year-old will retire after the race, bringing the curtain down on a career that has yielded 18 wins, almost \$1.1 million in prizemoney and established him among Australia's greatest modern jumpers. Maher rated Stern Idol as possibly the best jumper to have passed through his stable. "Bashboy won three Nationals, which is hard to do at a handicap level, but this horse is quicker and is quite possibly the best jumper I've ever had," Maher said. Bred in Ireland, Stern Idol raced in France before joining Maher's stable specifically for a jumps career in Australia. Maher said the lack of suitable races, rather than any physical issues, had prompted the retirement decision. "There's no reason why he couldn't race on, but there's only a couple of races a year that he can run in," he said. "He's just a cracking horse."

10 for Gingerbread Man

Fluro Neuro provided Yarradale Stud stallion Gingerbread Man (Shamardal) with his tenth individual stakes winner when causing a \$61 upset in the HG Bolton Sprint (Listed) at Belmont on the weekend. Trained by Simon Miller, the six-year-old gelding produced a late surge to defeat Snowdome (Rommel) by a short-head, Final Siren (I'm all The Talk) was third Madhi Girl (Winning Rupert) fourth. Mahdi Girl is currently catalogued in the upcoming Inglis Digital July (Late) sale. Fluro Neuro's has now won eight times from 34 starts, with earnings of close to \$600k. Purchased by Belhus Racing for \$75,000 from Yarradale Stud's draft at the Magic Millions Perth Yearling Sale, Fluro Neuro is the second stakes winner out of First Game (Soldier's Tale). Fluro Neuro joins fellow Gingerbread Man progeny Phanta and Red Can Man as winners of the HG Bolton Sprint.

Marhoona begins Spring build up

Golden Slipper and Galaxy winner Marhoona will begin her spring preparation in a barrier trial at Randwick on Friday. Trainer Michael Freedman said the four-year-old had returned in outstanding order ahead of the new season. Marhoona is likely to trial twice before resuming on September 5 in either the

Concorde Stakes (Gr 2, 1000m) or the Moir Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m).

Grand National beckons for Roc Up Ralph

Roc Up Ralph (Roc de Cambes) enhanced his Grand National Hurdles (4200m) credentials with a determined victory in the Open Hurdle (3100m) at Te Aroha on Sunday. Trained by Shaun and Emma Clotworthy, Roc Up Ralph settled well off the pace before producing a strong finishing burst under Hamish McNeill to defeat Jake by a long head, with Juwala third. "I was really pleased with him," Clotworthy said. "We were wanting to ride him patiently today and see him finding the line as his main target is down in Christchurch. There was plenty of speed in the race, so they came back to him and he was game. He jumped well and that is his sort of ground." The seven-year-old will now head straight to the Grand National Hurdles (4200m) at Riccarton on August 8, bypassing next week's Sydenham Hurdles. Now a winner of three hurdle races from six attempts, Roc Up Ralph has earned more than NZ\$145,000 since being purchased for just NZ\$6,250 through Gavelhouse in 2022. Bred by The Oaks Stud, Roc Up Ralph also provided Roc de Cambes with a double on the Te Aroha programme after Carignan won the Maiden Hurdle.

Duke Of Plumpton remains unbeaten over fences

Duke Of Plumpton (Bachelor Duke) maintained his unbeaten steeplechase record with a dominant victory in the Te Aroha Cup (3500m) on Sunday. Trained by Caley Myers, the ten-year-old followed his 31-length maiden steeplechase success at Woodville with another commanding display, cruising clear under Hamish McNeill to score by almost nine lengths. The race was disrupted by an early fall involving Uncle Charlie and Justice, with three fences later bypassed, but Duke Of Plumpton handled the changing circumstances comfortably. "His jumping was foot-perfect," McNeill said. "He stepped up against some nice horses and put them to bed very easily. Without getting too carried away early in his steeplechasing career, he's given me as nice a feel as any. He settles, jumps very cleanly and does what you ask of him." McNeill indicated Duke Of Plumpton was unlikely to head south for the Grand National Carnival, although his unbeaten record over fences has left Myers with several options. The versatile gelding has now won 11 races and more than \$310,000 in prizemoney. McNeill's victory, following his earlier success aboard Roc Up Ralph (Roc de Cambes), also secured him the 2025-26 jumps jockeys' premiership with eight wins.

Asia

Australian-breds for Korean International Meeting

Sunlight Power (Capitalist) is amongst 29 preliminary nominations of overseas horses for the Korea Cup (Gr 3, 1800m) on Sunday September 6. Trained by Ricky Yiu, the six-year-old's last win was in early 2025. Ricky Yiu has also nominated Victory Sky (U.S Navy Flag) in the Korea Sprint (Gr 3, 1200m) Other Australasians amongst the 40 Sprint nominations are Danny Shum pair, Blazing Wind (Deep Field) and Gorgeous Wind (Press Statement) as well as defending 2025 champion Self Improvement (Deep Field) from the Kenny Man stable and Victor The Winner (Toronado) trained by Pierre Ng.

RM1 Million Selangor Mile upset

Aquitaine (Deep Field) produced the biggest win of his career with a shock victory in Sunday's RM1 million Selangor Mile (1600m), giving trainer Simon Dunderdale a one-three finish in the feature. Sent out a \$61 outsider, the four-year-old surged late under CC Wong to deny Tunku Gold Cup (Listed, 1200m) winner Fortune Tree (Ardrossan) by a head, with stablemate Anjou Crown (Exceed And Excel) another half-length away in third. Pre-race favourite Choice Is Mine (Turn Me Loose), unbeaten in three Malaysian starts, finished seventh after settling near the tail. Remarkably, the first three home were all graduates of Inglis Digital, with Aquitaine, Fortune Tree and Anjou Crown all changing hands through the online auction platform for no less than \$70,000.

International

29 for New Bay

Repel (3 f ex Battlement, by Dansili) became the 29th individual stakes winner for New Bay (Dubawi) when taking Sunday's Prix La Sorellina (Listed, 1600m) at Mont-de-Marsan. Trained by Francis-Henri Graffard and ridden by Clément Lecoeuvre, the Juddmonte homebred defeated Blingy's Sister (Starspangledbanner) by a length and a half to register her second win from five starts. Repel is the fourth winner from five runners out of the Listed-placed Battlement, a three-quarter sister to champion sprinter and sire Bated Breath (Dansili) and a half-sister to St Leger (Gr 1, 1m6½f) winner Logician (Frankel). New Bay stands at Ballylinch Stud for a fee of €75,000 (approx. A\$123,000).

Two for Bayside Boy

Belisa Bay (2 f ex Belisa De Vega, by Fascinating Rock) became the second individual stakes winner for first-season sire Bayside Boy (New Bay) when taking Sunday's Criterium du Bequet (Listed, 1200m) at Mont-de-Marsan. Trained by Henri-François Devin and ridden by Pierre-Charles Boudot, the filly defeated Moondance (Thunder Moon) by half a length

to register her third win from five starts. A €23,000 Tattersalls Ireland September Yearling Sale purchase, Belisa Bay is the first foal out of dual winner Belisa De Vega, a half-sister to Listed winner Royal Bay Cen (New Bay). Her second dam is Cornwallis Stakes (Gr 3, 5f) winner Royal Razalma (Lope De Vega). Bayside Boy stands at Ballylinch Stud for a fee of €12,000 (approx. A\$19,600).

First for Erik The Red

Erik Dubois (2 c ex Comtesse Dubois, by Count Dubois) provided Erik The Red (Captain Al) with his first Group 1 winner when taking Sunday's Champion Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) at Greyville. Trained by Louis Goosen and ridden by Lyle Hewitson, the two-year-old defeated Kazenoyoni (Danon Platina) by a neck, with fellow Erik The Red colt Red Spice finishing third. A R375,000 (approx. A\$32,600) Cape Racing Sales Premier Yearling Sale purchase, Erik Dubois is the fourth winner from eight runners out of Listed winner Comtesse Dubois, herself a daughter of Group 3 winner Katherine (Rakeen).

Group One to Too Darn Hot

Hotazhell (Too Darn Hot) claimed a second top flight success when winning the Grosser Dallmayr-Preis (Gr 1, 2000m) at Munich on Sunday. A winner of 5 from 14 races, Hotazhell hadn't won since defeating of Delacroix (Dubawi) in the Futurity Trophy (Gr 1, 1600m) at Doncaster in October 2024 but held off Timeforshowcasing (Showcasing) and Wimbledon Hawkeye (Kameko) in a classic finish. A Gns 70,000 purchase by Linehan Bloodstock from Diamond Stud Farm (UK) at the 2023 Tatts October Yearling Sale (Book 2).

Buffalo Storm Cody successfully defends Mercury Sprint

Buffalo Storm Cody (4 g Buffalo Bill Cody ex Musical Romance, by Trippi) secured the third Group 1 victory of his career when successfully defending Sunday's Mercury Sprint (Gr 1, 1200m) at Greyville. Trained by Tony Peter and ridden by Gavin Lerena, the four-year-old defeated Jet Force (Master Of My Fate) by a

length to register his tenth win from 20 starts. Buffalo Storm Cody, who became the first Group 1 winner for his sire in last year's renewal, also landed the Computaform Sprint (Gr 1, 1000m) earlier this year. He was purchased for R410,000 (approx. A\$35,000) at the Cape Yearling Sale. His sire Buffalo Bill Cody is an Irish bred son of the late champion sire Redoute's Choice (Danehill).

Eight On Eighteen lands Champions Cup

Eight On Eighteen (4 c Lancaster Bomber ex Sempre Libre, by Captain Al) added a fourth elite-level victory when taking Sunday's HKJC Champions Cup (Gr 1, 1800m) at Greyville. Trained by Justin Snaith and ridden by Richard Fourie, the colt defeated stablemate See It Again (Twice Over) by a length, with Main Defender (Pathfork) a further two lengths away in third. A R700,000 (approx. A\$60,900) National Yearling Sale purchase, Eight On Eighteen is one of two winners from three runners out of the unraced Captain Al (Al Mufti) mare Sempre Libre, whose hails from an elite family that includes Pocket Power Stakes (Listed, 1950m) winner Future Free (Futura). The family is one of South Africa's finest, with his second dam Mystic Spring (Royal Academy) producing ten stakes winners. Lancaster Bomber passed away in 2021.

Sword Of State becomes third winner for State Of Rest

State Of Rest (Starspangledbanner) sired his third Irish winner when Sword Of State scored by one and three-quarter lengths from OTI owned, Seaxburh (Saxon Warrior) at Gowran Park. Trained by Brendan Duke, the two-year-old filly led throughout to win the Irish EBF Auction Series Maiden (7f) at her second start, having debuted seventh of nine at the Curragh six days earlier. Sword Of State is a half-sister to stakes winner Smuggler's Moon (Danehill Dancer) and the seventh winner from ten runners out of Alchemilla (Dubai Destination), an unraced half-sister to Group 2 winner Strategic Prince. 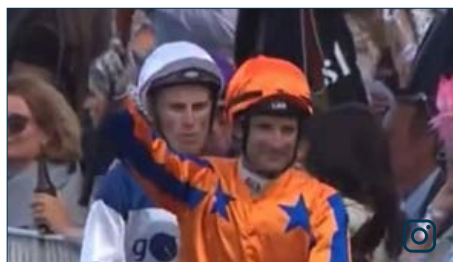

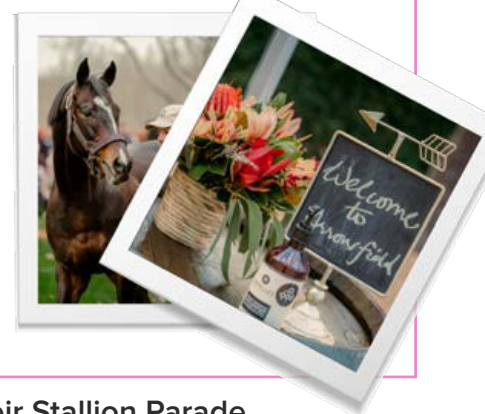
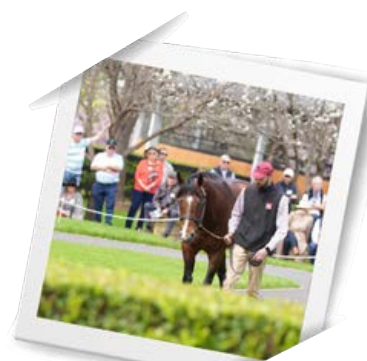
