Classy line-up of new recruits to hit NSW

Having taken a look at the new stallions hitting Victoria for 2026 on Tuesday, today is the turn of New South Wales. We take a look at 11 of the state's fledgling recruits as the stallions prepare for upcoming parades.

The new addition with the highest profile to Australian viewers is likely Darley's Tentyris (Street Boss), a dual Group 1 scorer on the track that will be introduced at a fee of \$88,000 (all fees inc GST).

A son of Street Boss (Street Cry), who stands at Darley's Northwood Park in Victoria, the rising four-year-old enjoyed a stellar racing career.

Winning the Todman Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) as a juvenile, Tentyris would go on to land both the Coolmore Stud Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) and Lightning Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m).

His win in the Coolmore came in a record time and the Lightning Stakes success provided him with a Group 1 victory at weight-for-age level. In doing so, he became only the fourth three-year-old colt to win the Lightning in the past 25 years.

Boomtown Boss heads south for Aurie's Star

Boomtown Boss (Spirit Of Boom) will make his Melbourne debut in Saturday's Aurie's Star Handicap (Gr 3, 1200m) at Flemington. Brisbane trainer Tony Gollan expects the spacious Flemington straight to suit Boomtown Boss, describing him as a big-track galloper whose ideal distance is between 1300 and 1400 metres.

A strong performance could see the sprinter remain in Melbourne for further starts, although a return home to prepare for the Queensland Summer Carnival is also under consideration.

Continued from page 2 “Tentyris was a top class two-year-old, a multiple stakes-winning two-year-old. After a narrow defeat in the Blue Diamond and a brilliant win in the Todman he unfortunately missed his opportunity in the Slipper,” Godolphin Australia’s managing director, Andy Makiv, said.

“As a three-year-old, his stunning win in the Coolmore was breathtaking and his win in the Lightning, spinetingling.”

Bred and raced by Godolphin, Tentyris is a half-brother to winner Dios (Lonhro) out of the winning Exceed And Excel (Danehill) mare Deity, herself a half-sister to Listed winners Maternal (Street Cry) and Eleusa (Redoute’s Choice) being out of the Group 1-winning mare Divine Madonna (Hurricane Sky).

Another big-priced new addition to the NSW stallion ranks is Super Seth (Dundeel), the rising ten-year-old that has made the move from New Zealand’s Waikato Stud to Coolmore’s Jerry’s Plains-based farm after a huge deal was brokered for the sire earlier this year.

A winner of the Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) on the track back in 2019, Super Seth was crowned New Zealand Champion First Season Sire in 2024 and also added the Second Season Sires’ title the following year.

With yearlings selling for up to \$950,000 in 2026, and four Group 1 winners already in the bank, Super Seth has been introduced

at Coolmore at a fee of \$137,500 – meaning he has the equal-sixth highest stallion fee in Australia.

“Super Seth has been on our radar for a while now and he strikes us as a stallion that can make a significant impact on the Australian breeding industry,” Coolmore Australia principal Tom Magnier said.

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Continued from page 3 “For a young horse, the trajectory that he is on is something that is very rarely seen. To produce three Group 1 winners in Australia from his first crop including two Guineas winners and follow it up with a Champion Two-Year-Old in his second, is an amazing achievement. He is going to be ideal for so many Australian mares, both physically and on pedigree.”

Coolmore’s other new addition for 2026 will be Delacroix (Dubawi), who is shuttling over from the operation’s Irish base and will stand at a fee of \$38,500.

A Group 3 winner and narrow Group 1 runner-up at two, the four-year-old son of Dubawi (Dubai Millennium) excelled as a three-year-old, landing a pair of Group 3 successes on his return before wins in the Coral-Eclipse (Gr 1, 1m 2f) and Irish Champion Stakes (Gr 1, 1m 2f) – the former win seeing him overcome one of the world’s best in Ombudsman (Night Of Thunder).

Bred by the Tepin Syndicate and raced in Derrick Smith’s Coolmore silks, Delacroix really is a stallion bred in the purple. He is a half-brother to Group 1 winner Grateful (Galileo) being the fourth foal out of the outstanding six-time elite-level scorer Tepin (Bernstein), herself a half-sister to Grade 2 winner Vyjack (Into Mischief).

Having already established a mainstay base in Victoria, fellow powerhouse operation Yulong now has an arm in NSW after taking over the historic Segenhoe Stud.

Standing at their new base will be stallion recruits Devil Night (Extreme Choice) and Private Harry (Harry Angel), joining current sires Alabama Express (Redoute’s Choice) and shuttler Lucky Vega (Lope De Vega), who have also made the journey from Victoria for the 2026 season.

A \$1.4 million purchase for Yulong out of his breeder Kingstar Farm’s draft at the

2024 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale, Devil Night is a son of Newgate’s phenomenon Extreme Choice (Not A Single Doubt) and is a half-brother to dual Group 3 winner Our Playboy (Sebring) being out of the Shamardal (Giant’s Causeway) mare Mischief Night, herself a half-sister to Group 1 scorer and current Yulong sire Pierata (Pierro).

Having debuted with a courageous second in the Blue Diamond Prelude (Gr 3, 1100m), the colt then backed up a fortnight later to land the Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) itself, defeating Tentyris and emulating his sire in the process.

Returning as a three-year-old, Devil Night continued to produce at the top level, finishing runner-up in the Zeditave Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) and third in the weight-for-age William Reid Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m). His fee has been set at \$33,000.

Continued from page 5 Meanwhile, Private Harry is the first son of Harry Angel (Dark Angel) to retire to stud. Bred by Rheinwood Pastoral, the colt was purchased by Kurrinda Bloodstock and Doyle Racing for a fee of \$115,000 at the 2023 Inglis Classic Yearling Sale before then being acquired by Yulong in a private deal.

A winner of The Galaxy (Gr 1, 1100m), Private Harry also scored in the inaugural \$3 million Sunlight Plate (1100m), where he defeated subsequent Golden Slipper (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Lady Of Camelot (Written Tycoon).

"Devil Night is a hugely exciting addition to our 2026 stallion roster. He's by Extreme Choice, a sire with an incredible strike rate himself, and a Group 1-winning two-year-old like his sire, who trained on to beat elite sprinters at weight-for-age," Yulong's chief operating officer, Sam Fairgray, said.

"Private Harry offers elite-level consistency and some of the fastest sectionals we've seen in recent years, everything you expect from a sire line renowned for pure speed. He's also a strong, masculine, good-looking colt with plenty of substance, exactly the type of speed breeders gravitate towards."

A pair of stallions that will stand for an introductory fee of \$27,500 are Arrowfield's shuttler Lead Artist (Dubawi) and Vinery's recent Oakleigh Plate (Gr 1, 1100m) hero Tropicus (Too Darn Hot).

The former, who was bred and raced in the colours of Juddmonte Farms, was a dual Group 3 winner at three before returning as a four-year-old to land the prestigious Lockinge Stakes (Gr 1, 1m) at Newbury.

He is the first foal out of the Group 2-winning Frankel (Galileo) mare Obligate, herself out of an unraced half-sister to elite-level winner and breed-shaping stallion Dansili (Danehill) and fellow Group 1 winners Banks Hill (Danehill), Cacique (Danehill) and Champs Elysees (Danehill).

"I haven't been more excited about a stallion since Danehill," Arrowfield's John Messara said. "I haven't seen a pedigree like this, with that level of pre-potency on both sides, anywhere. He's by Dubawi, who's one of the hottest stallions in the world, he's out of a Frankel mare - it's a pedigree from heaven."

Meanwhile, February's Oakleigh scorer Tropicus is the highest-rated sprinting son of Too Darn Hot (Dubawi) to be retired to stud.

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Continued from page 6 Bred and raced by Kia Ora Stud, the rising five-year-old carried the highest weight to victory in the Oakleigh since the introduction of weight metrics in 1973 and no colt has rated higher to win the Oakleigh Plate over the past ten years.

"Tropicus is already attracting strong support in his first season," Vinery's general manager Adam White said. "As a Group 1-winning sprinter by Too Darn Hot, he offers breeders access to an exceptional sireline and profiles as a horse capable of producing early runners."

Rounding off our selection of new NSW-based stallions are Newgate's Wodeton (Wootton Bassett), Newhaven's Cool Archie (Cool Aza Beel) and Evergreen Stud's Reserve Bank (Capitalist) – with all three standing for a fee of \$16,500.

A four-length winner on debut in his only start outside stakes company, Wodeton

produced top-class placings in the Golden Slipper and Golden Rose (Gr 1, 1400m), as well as a further four Group-race placings.

Bred by Segenhoe Stud, the son of late shuttler Wootton Bassett (Iffraaj) was purchased for \$1.6 million by Tom Magnier for Coolmore – who have joined forces with Newgate to stand the colt.

"He demolished a quality field on debut and was denied Golden Slipper glory by the narrowest possible margin," Newgate's Henry Field said. "He was the highest-rated colt of his generation and came within a nose of Australian racing immortality."

Cool Archie was also a high-quality juvenile, landing the Spirit Of Boom Classic (Gr 2, 1200m), BRC Sires' Produce Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) and J.J. Atkins Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) during the 2024-25 campaign.

Bred by Newhaven, the son of Cool Aza Beel (Savabeel) was purchased for \$100,000 by Mick Malone Bloodstock at the 2024 Magic

Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale and will return home to his birthplace for the 2026 breeding season.

"There have been very few two-year-olds capable of putting together five wins in succession, four of those being long-established Queensland stakes races, and for me that is one of his major selling points," Newhaven principal John Kelly said.

"His JJ Atkins win confirmed his credentials as a stallion prospect, and when it became clear his racing career had ended, we were very keen to bring him home to Newhaven."

Finally, 2025 The Goodwood (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Reserve Bank secured his stud future when he was purchased by Botty's Bloodstock via the inaugural Inglis Digital Bull Ring Sale last month. Standing at Evergreen Stud, not far from Newcastle airport in Heatherbrae, Reserve Bank was the last stallion announced and may be the first to be seen by those planning their tours next month.

Champagne Hero (Maurice) and Conchiero (Pierata) will represent Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott in Wednesday's Nutrien East Region Livestock Handicap (1550m) at Kensington. Champagne Hero enters the race following a narrow second to Iceman (Rubick) at his second start this preparation. Champagne Hero contested the Gloaming Stakes (Gr 3, 1800m) and Spring Champion Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) last season. Bott expects the gelding will appreciate longer distances later in his campaign.

Eviction Notice chasing maiden breakthrough

Eviction Notice (Stay Inside) will bid to break his maiden at Kensington on Wednesday. Second last, but only three lengths behind the winner, in the Breeders' Plate (Gr 3, 1000m) on debut, Eviction Notice placed in the Canonbury Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) and Silver Slipper Stakes (Gr 2, 1100m) before being gelded following a midfield effort in the Black Opal Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m). He resumed with a runner-up finish behind Castillo King (Farnan) earlier this month. Victory on Wednesday could earn Eviction Notice a start in The Rosebud (Listed, 1100m) at Rosehill on August 15.

Ride Like Michelle makes winning debut

Ride Like Michelle (Russian Camelot) made an impressive start to her career when winning a 975-metre maiden on debut for trainer Patrick Payne and jockey Alana Kelly. The two-year-old filly overhauled favourite What Once Was (Overshare) to score by 0.8 lengths, having remained with Patrick Payne following the end of his training partnership with sister Michelle in March. Ride Like Michelle was purchased by John Foote Bloodstock for \$90,000 at the Inglis Classic Yearling Sale for Hong Kong-based So Bloodstock. She is out of a half-sister to Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) winner Vow And Declare (Declaration Of War).

Freedman lands Swan Hill four-timer

Mitchell Freedman continued his outstanding run of form by saddling four winners at Swan Hill on Tuesday. Cicconi Rain (Nicconi) opened the meeting with victory before Budjik Queen (Churchill), Wazza (Ghaiyyath) and Sacramental (Sacred Falls) completed a memorable day for the Group 1-winning trainer.

Spring Stars continue to return

Queen Elizabeth Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) winner Sir Delius (Frankel) will make his first spring appearance in Friday's barrier trials at

Randwick with a likely return in the Makybe Diva Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) on September 12. Sir Delius was favourite for last year's Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) and Melbourne Cup before being ruled out of both races by Racing Victoria's strict veterinary protocols. That embargo was lifted in April.

Sheza Alibi pleases in Pakenham jump-out

Dual Group 1 winner Sheza Alibi (Saxon Warrior) pleased co-trainer Peter Moody when second in her first jump-out at Pakenham on Tuesday. Sheza Alibi travelled strongly along the inside before finishing behind stablemate Ole Dancer (Ole Kirk), with Moody indicating the mare had only been asked to stretch her legs. She is likely to trial again over 1000 metres in a fortnight before connections determine her first-up assignment, with the Memsie Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Caulfield on August 29 an option.

RQ introduces measures to reduce scratchings

Racing Queensland (RQ) will introduce a progressive acceptors system from September 1 as part of a series of measures aimed at reducing scratching rates and improving field sizes. The system will allow trainers to view the horses accepted for any race in which they have a nomination before the acceptance deadline. The number of emergencies declared for each race will also be capped at five. Average TAB race field sizes have declined from 9.6 runners in 2023-24 to 9.56 in 2024-25 and 9.3 during the most recent financial year. Racing Queensland is also considering assigning barriers when weights are declared, providing trainers with further information before acceptances close. Acting chief executive Lachlan Murray said large scratching volumes had negatively affected wagering turnover and returns to the industry, while Queensland Australian Trainers Association executive Richard Andrews welcomed the progressive acceptances initiative.

Galloway set for Gatton debut

Third-generation jockey William Galloway will make his race-riding debut at Gatton on Thursday. The 18-year-old Gold Coast rider is the son of Group 1-winning jockey Scott Galloway and grandson of former Queensland jockey Peter Cuddihy, who rode at Group level before retiring in 2006. Scott Galloway competed successfully throughout Queensland before retiring from race riding in July 2024. William, who has a listed riding weight of 49 kilograms.

BOBS guide released

Racing NSW has released the 2029 BOBS Sire Guide for stallions in 2026 that are paid up for the Breeder Owner Bonus Scheme (BOBS) whose progeny will turn 2YO in 2029, 90 stallions have been nominated. The Sire Guide also contains information about BOBS and BOBS Extra. The full colour 2029 BOBS Sire Guide is available contacting Racing NSW - bobs@racingnsw.com.au or (02) 9551 7605.

Home Affairs vs Snitzel may go to wire

Home Affairs (I Am Invincible) remains a chance to add the Champion Two-Year-Old Sire title to his leading first-season sire honours, trailing Snitzel (Redoute's Choice) by \$32,445 at the time of writing on Tuesday. Snitzel will be represented by Threads in Wednesday's \$60,000 race at Randwick and has Albert Palais engaged at Kembla Grange on Thursday. Home Affairs has three juveniles nominated across Geelong and Scone on Friday.

Stokes forms training partnership with son Tommy

Group 1-winning trainer Phillip Stokes will begin training in partnership with his eldest son Tommy from Saturday. Tommy has managed the South Australian arm of the stable for the past three seasons, helping the operation secure multiple Adelaide trainers' premierships. He previously gained international experience with Darley in Japan, his move into the partnership follows a season working alongside his father in Victoria. Phillip Stokes' youngest son Kerrin has since taken charge of the Adelaide stable and helped the team secure another premiership this season.

Digital ticketing expanded to all Victorian meetings

Owners with runners at Victorian race meetings will have access to digital raceday tickets from Saturday, August 1, following the launch of the second phase of Racing Victoria's (RV) Owners Digital Ticketing Platform.

Developed by RV in partnership with the Thoroughbred Racehorse Owners Association (TROA) and supported by Victoria's racing clubs, the system will be introduced at every Victorian thoroughbred meeting during the 2026-27 season.

Digital tickets will provide owners and their guests with access to their applicable raceday privileges, including racecourse admission, members' areas, the mounting yard and owners' lounges, along with complimentary food and beverage entitlements where available.

Owners will receive email and SMS notifications shortly after acceptances advising that their tickets are available. They can then log into the platform using the email address linked to their Racing Australia account and a one-time passcode sent by email.

Tickets can be downloaded to Apple and Google digital wallets or shared with guests through SMS, email and WhatsApp.

The platform was launched in September last year, initially allowing owners to access a digital version of their Owner Gold Card. The ticketing expansion follows successful trials at selected Victorian meetings throughout July and will commence at Flemington and Hamilton on Saturday.

Owners unable to access their tickets online will still receive complimentary admission for themselves and their guests before collecting physical tickets from the relevant raceday ticketing office or owners' concierge.

RV chief operating officer Vaughn Lynch said the initiative would streamline and standardise the ticket redemption process while reducing queues and wait times on course.

TROA chairman Jonathan Munz welcomed the rollout, saying the ability to access and share tickets directly from a mobile phone represented a significant improvement to the raceday experience for Victorian owners.

Project Stamina identifies NZ racecourses at risk of closure

New Zealand Thoroughbred Racing, Harness Racing New Zealand and TAB NZ have released Project Stamina, a long-term infrastructure roadmap that could result in the closure of several racing and training venues.

Funded by TAB NZ, the project combines an independent National Masterplan prepared by consultancy RCP with One Equine View, the joint position adopted by NZTR and HRNZ on how the recommendations should be implemented across both codes.

The review found New Zealand's racing footprint contains more venues than can be sustainably supported, with operating and capital expenditure spread too thinly as horse populations, participant numbers and industry economics have changed.

Project Stamina recommends directing investment towards fewer, higher-quality facilities located close to concentrations of horses, participants and racing activity. Priorities include reliable racing and training surfaces, stronger wagering performance, sustainable revenue and suitable facilities for horses and industry participants.

Among the thoroughbred venues proposed for closure are Trentham and Rotorua, while dual-code tracks Gore, Hāwera and Ōamaru are also under threat.

Trentham's inclusion is expected to attract significant opposition given its historic importance and status as Wellington's remaining racecourse.

NZTR and HRNZ did not support all recommendations in the independent report, rejecting proposed closures involving Matamata, Te Aroha, Ōtaki, Whanganui, Ashburton, Timaru and Motukarara. Te Rapa and Cambridge's thoroughbred tracks remain subject to future business cases because of their connection to the proposed Waikato Greenfields project, which would replace both venues should it proceed.

More than 50 workshops and meetings were held with clubs, participants and industry organisations during the review, which also considered more than a decade of previous strategic work, including the Messina Report.

Outgoing NZTR chair Russell Warwick stressed the recommendations were not final and said affected clubs would be given an opportunity to challenge the findings and present their cases.

The roadmap also supports retaining a network of smaller community venues, recognising their role in maintaining racing's regional presence and developing industry participants. Implementation is expected to occur over several years, supported by business cases, investment planning and further consultation with clubs and stakeholders.

Sottsass stood the 2026 northern hemisphere breeding season at Shizunai Stallion Station.

UK: Scandinavia backs up Ascot with second Goodwood Cup

The Aidan O'Brien-trained Scandinavia (4c Justify - Fabulous by Galileo) supplemented his last-start win in the Ascot Gold Cup (Gr 1, 2m 4f) with a second-straight victory in Tuesday's Goodwood Cup (Gr 1, 2m) at Glorious Goodwood. Ridden by Ryan Moore, the four-year-old colt faced off against his Ascot rival Trawlerman (Golden Horn) but the battle could never really get into full swing, with the loose-running Amiloc (Postponed) coming across Trawlerman down the home straight and effectively handing Scandinavia with the lead. However, it is unlikely the result would have changed given the winner pulled eight and a half lengths clear of the Godolphin horse. There was a further three-quarters of a length back to the third-placed Rahiebb (Frankel). "I was just talking to Aidan there and it's probably as good a staying performance as he's ever seen," Moore said. "I never asked him for everything either. It was nice for him to have a horse to follow all the way, he probably thinks he got beat! Very good horse. Unbelievable race record now. His stride never shortened, he just kept galloping all the way to the line. What more can you say? He couldn't have done anymore than what he done today. He likes fast ground, he's a high class horse and hopefully there's a few more good days to come."

Sonar on target for Ryder Stakes success

Promising two-year-old Sonar (U S Navy Flag) takes on stakes company for the first time in Thursday's Ryder Stakes (Listed, 1200m) at Otaki. Bred by The Oaks Stud and raced by farm principal Dick Karreman after being passed in at the 2025 New Zealand Bloodstock National Yearling Sale, Sonar impressed when winning a 1000-metre trial at Avondale before making a successful debut over 1150 metres on a Heavy 8 track at Te Aroha earlier this month. A strong

performance at Otaki could earn Sonar an opportunity in several lucrative spring features

Six for Sottsass

Ridden by Cieren Fallon, the son of No Nay Never (Scat Daddy) produced a strong late run to lead late on and hold on by a neck from Rogue Diplomat (Calxy). There was a further three-quarters of a length back to the front-running Witness Stand (Expert Eye), who won the 2025 renewal, in third.

UK: Bow Echo bids for Group 1 hat-trick in Sussex

Unbeaten three-year-old Bow Echo (Night Of Thunder) will chase a third consecutive Group 1 victory when he renews his rivalry with Gstaad (Starspangledbanner) in Wednesday's Sussex Stakes (Gr 1, 1m) at Goodwood. The George Boughey-trained colt has already won the English 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1m) and St James's Palace Stakes (Gr 1, 1m) this season, with Boughey describing him as the fastest horse he has trained. Opera Ballo (Ghaiyyath) shapes as another leading contender after the Jebel Hatta (Gr 1, 1800m) winner finished third

following a front-running effort in the Queen Anne Stakes (Gr 1, 1m) at Royal Ascot. Charlie Appleby reported Opera Ballo had recovered well from that performance, while jockey Billy Loughnane, who has ridden both runners, said he would not swap Bow Echo despite holding the Godolphin colt in high regard. Lake Forest is also entered but contested, and won, Tuesday's Lennox Stakes so is an unlikely runner.

UK: Dual Group 1 winner Ghanaati dies aged 20

Shadwell homebred Ghanaati (Giant's Causeway), winner of the English 1,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1m) and Coronation Stakes (Gr 1, 1m) in 2009, has died at the age of 20. Shadwell racing manager Angus Gold described Ghanaati as an outstanding miler who provided the operation with two memorable Group 1 victories during the spring and summer of 2009. Trained by Barry Hills, Ghanaati won three of her six starts, including 1,000 Guineas at Newmarket and the Coronation Stakes at Royal Ascot. Ghanaati

produced seven winners from as many runners, her leading progeny including three-time Group 2 winner Mutasaabeq (Invincible Spirit), Mahab Al Shimaal Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) winner Wafy (Dubawi) and Royal Hunt Cup (1m) winner Afaak (Oasis Dream).
