Pembrey the prelude to a breeding bonanza for Kia Ora

With exciting filly Pembrey (Prague) set to carry Kia Ora's colours in Saturday's Silver Shadow Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) and more than 100 mares about to deliver some stars of the future, it's a busy time of year for the farm's general manager Shane Wright - but the Irishman wouldn't have it any other way.

A sticky draw has hampered Pembrey's prospects of adding a second stakes win to her racing resumé, particularly as she prefers to lead from the front, but with the man they call 'J-Mac' reuniting their partnership, Kia Ora's homebred filly is in reassuringly safe hands.

Given that the Hunter Valley stallion parades will be in full swing, most notably on Saturday morning when their next-door neighbour Vinery Stud throws open its doors, Wright will instead leave trackside duties at Randwick in the capable hands of the famed farm's racing manager Luke Wilkinson.

Vinery's elite roster has been significantly bolstered this season with the addition of new kid on the block Tropicus (Too Darn Hot), who now faces the daunting task of emulating the seismic achievements at stud of his fellow Oakleigh Plate (Gr 1, 1100m) winners Snippets (Lunchtime), Fastnet Rock (Danehill), Snitzel (Redoute's Choice) and Starspangledbanner (Choisir) - to name but four revered bulls.

Pellicle tops Magic Millions sale at \$180,000

Proven Group winner producer Pellicle (Sepoy) topped the Magic Millions Digital (14-19 August) Sale when she sold for \$180,000 on Wednesday.

Offered by Baramul Stud, as agent, Pellicle was the final lot of the online offering and was snapped up by leading bloodstock agent Guy Mulcaster.

Closely related to Divine Madonna (Hurricane Sky) and from the family of recent Group 1 winners Tentyris (Street Boss), Baraqiel (Snitzel) and Autumn Angel (The Autumn Sun), Pellicle is in foal to former crack Godolphin galloper Broadside (Too Darn Hot).

Continued from page 2 Over the coming weeks, 40 members of Kia Ora's 115-strong broodmare band – including Pembrey's dam Se Sauver (Bel Esprit) – will make the four-minute journey along Segenhoe Road for a first date with Tropicus, whose enviable bloodlines and premium performances prompted a flurry of bookings as soon as the inevitable announcement came that he would be retired to stud.

The 'no vacancies' sign has now been erected outside Vinery, although any broodmare owners with a spare \$77,000 in their bank accounts might be able to access

Farnan (Not A Single Doubt), with limited opportunities still available for the prolific stallion who is beginning to demonstrate the same prowess in the breeding barn as he showed on the racetrack.

At \$27,500 (inc GST), Tropicus' introductory service fee is precisely half that commanded by the 2020 Golden Slipper (Gr 1, 1200m) hero when he was initially retired to stud, but Wright is steadfast in his belief that the five-year-old – whose stakes-placed dam Extensible (Exceed And Excel) was also bred by Kia Ora – has all the attributes required to follow closely in Farnan's footsteps.

"He's got the farm's brand on him and, as we've seen with Too Darn Hot and his progeny, it's a sire line that's going from strength to strength in Australia so he's extremely well credentialled to be a success as a stallion," Wright told ANZ News.

"We're very keen to get behind him in his first season at stud, so we'll be sending around 40 mares to him – including 20 stakes winners. The other 20 are mostly either stakes placed or

their dams are black type producers, so we're supporting him very strongly because we really believe in him.

"I think he should be quite easy to breed to, with the Too Darn Hot sire line and his mare by Exceed And Excel there's plenty of Aussie appeal in there. His pedigree is one thing but he's also a beautiful specimen. He's got plenty of Exceed And Excel about him and he's a good size [16.1 hands], but he's also got that natural strength about him.

"If you've got a big mare he'll inject some quality into her, but he's also the perfect match for those small, sharp mares which is why we've chosen to send him a variety of our mares. They include Jennifer Eccles, who was a Group 1 winner and a headline mare in New Zealand. Her first foal [Farnicle] has two stakes placings, and her second foal Fovea won her first trial on Tuesday morning by seven lengths.

"For obvious reasons we have a lot of time for her, she's currently in foal to Farnan again but we thought Tropicus **Continued on page 5**

Continued from page 3 deserved a mare of her calibre in his first season. Others include Mooneista, who won two stakes races [for Joseph O'Brien] and ran fourth behind Nature Strip at Royal Ascot.

"Kimochi's dam Summer Fun will also be served by Tropicus, as well as two of the farm's matriarchs in Gypsy Robin, who is the dam of Wild Ruler, and Breeders Cup' winner More Than Real, who is Lady of Camelot's granddam. The list goes on so he'll be spoilt for choice, but we're willing to put a lot of faith in him because we know how good he was as a racehorse and we have high hopes for him as a stallion."

Farnan, who began his active service at Kia Ora before heading down to the road to Vinery following the amalgamation of the two stallion rosters earlier this year, will also be ably supported by up to 30 of the farm's mares.

They include Kia Ora's \$625,000 Inglis Chairman's purchase Ippodamia's Girl (Stormy Atlantic), a stakes winner in her native America; Group 2 victor Sassy Boom (Spirit Of Boom);

and Group 1-placed mare Ellicazoom (Testa Rossa), whose second foal Celerity (Exceed And Excel) won this year's Manihi Classic (Listed, 1100m) for Godolphin.

Given that the best is almost certainly yet to come for Farnan, with his speedy son Ninja appearing a Group 1 winner in waiting and the quality of his mares set to increase year on year given his feats to date in his embryonic career, a changing of the guard may well be afoot in Australia's stallion ranks.

But while Kia Ora has a vested interest in both Farnan and Tropicus, as well as fellow Vinery resident Captivant (Capitalist), Wright is quick to point out that the farm is willing and able to explore opportunities outside the Hunter Valley bubble.

"Obviously with the restructure and Kia Ora's significant investment in Vinery, naturally we see it as a great opportunity to access such a powerful roster including Ole Kirk, who like Farnan will be a very important stallion for the entire industry moving forward," Wright told ANZ News.

"With Barramul also sending many of their better mares there I wouldn't think there is a stallion roster in the country which will receive greater support, but we're by no means only tied to Vinery. We're fortunate to support other young stallions we have some shares in, including the likes of Return To Conquer and Sword Of State.

"We co-bred Return To Conquer so we're very excited to see what he can do in his first season at Waikato, and we'll be sending him a couple of mares we think will really suit him. The same applies to Sword Of State, who is doing great things at Cambridge Stud. We have a long-standing relationship with the Lindsay family, and we're excited to send the dam of Warwoven [Needle And Thread] to Sword Of State this year.

"Warwoven was an outstanding two-year-old colt and he looks to have come back even better as a three-year-old, judging by his trial win over Guest House last week. So hopefully the dam can deliver another star performer for us next year."

Green Spaces set for Winx return

Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) winner Green Spaces (Street Boss) is set to make his seasonal return in Saturday's Winx Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Randwick. Although he is not expected to be pushing the likes of likely rivals Autumn Glow (The Autumn Sun) and Sheza Alibi (Saxon Warrior) in the Group 1 sprint, jockey Rachel King feels the comeback run is an important one now the gelding enters his four-year-old campaign. "You never know how these three-year-olds are going to come back into their four-year-old year, but he has definitely grown. He's taller again, and he's filled out again," King said. "He's got that cool attitude as well. He's a proper dude, so I'm looking forward to seeing where he's at. Obviously, it's way short of his best distance-wise, but it will be a good starting point to kick him off and see where he's at."

Tulloch Lodge to have trio in Silver Shadow

Tulloch Lodge will send a trio of runners to Saturday's Silver Shadow Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) at Randwick, with Reachin' Out (Stay Inside) heading up the three. The four-year-old mare made a winning debut at Randwick-Kensington in March before then running seventh in the Percy Sykes Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m), and has performed well in two trials prior to this weekend. "We originally had her pencilled in for some tougher tasks first-up, then we settled on some easier tasks after her trials," Adrian Bott, who trains in partnership with Gai Waterhouse, said. "Then we saw the nominations and after her work on Saturday, we thought she deserved to kick off there." Agrarian Girl (Tassort) also kicks off her campaign in the feature after a two-start juvenile campaign that saw her win the Lonhro Plate (Listed, 1000m) and run second in the Reisling Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m), while multiple stakes placegetter By Choice (Written By) rounds

Amongst the racehorses, five-year-old gelding Point Rocks (Blue Point) was knocked down to Tom Wolfe for \$30,000. In the race fillies category, Darby Racing's Scottish Pearl (Gleneagles) also sold for \$30,000 and Acquired Taste (Pierro), offered by Peters Investments, realised \$25,000.

The freshly turned yearlings as part of the Forest View Farm Unreserved Dispersal attracted strong interest, with eight of the 13 yearlings receiving more than 20 bids. The Ingratiating (Frosted)-Rebel Assault (Excelebration) colt, a half-brother to Gimcrack Stakes winner Siren Assault (Rich Enuff), topped the draft selling to Fenix Racing for \$55,000.

Over the past two Magic Millions Digital Sales the Forest View Farm Unreserved Dispersal Sale has grossed over \$1.8 million.

She will be better suited getting out to 1400 and 1600 metres this prep. She will stay in the Princess Series, but she may just find them a little sharp first time out."

Widdup Group 1 dreaming with Savvy

Dual group 2 scorer Savvy Hallie (Hellbent) could well have a mountain to climb later on this season as trainer Brad Widdup has not ruled out a potential crack at The Everest (Gr 1, 1200m). The now four-year-old mare was denied a Group 1 success very narrowly last season when a 0.2-length second in the Surround Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) back in February and will return in the Toy Show Quality (Gr 3, 1100m) at Randwick on Saturday. "She's great, I'm very happy with her," Widdup told Racing NSW. "We've had a good preparation leading up to Saturday. Hopefully she's a bit better, but she's pretty good as we know. If they go out and come back the same you're in strife but she's definitely developed. We've had a great prep until now and fingers crossed she keeps going."

Sandown for Beast Mode in Carlyon

Co-trainer Ben Hayes is disappointed that this year's renewal of the Carlyon Stakes (Gr 3, 1000m) will be run at Sandown instead of The Valley, but is happy to take on the race with consistent gelding Beast Mode (Better Than Ready). The gelded seven-year-old has two wins from just five outings at The Valley, but with that track out of commission for nearly another year, the Carlyon has been moved to Sandown for 2026. "It was the perfect track for him," Hayes,

who trains in partnership with his brothers JD and Will, said. "He's a fast horse, so let fast horses be fast. He can get rolling early and I reckon he can run well. We're happy with him."

Knight's Choice enjoys jumpout victory

The 2024 Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) hero Knight's Choice (Extreme Choice) produced a pleasing jump-out victory at Caulfield Heath on Wednesday as the now seven-year-old appreciated returning to a better track. The son of Extreme Choice (Not A Single Doubt) has raced just four times since his Cup success, for a best-placed sixth in the 2025 So You Think Stakes (1500m), and co-trainer John Symons admitted the last 12 months has been difficult. "We couldn't be happier with where he is at," Symons, who trains in partnership with Sheila Laxon, said. "He's had a mixed way of life since he won the Cup. He's always had the ability to do it, [but he's a] wet track duffer, [but a] dry track, like today, you see what he can do. Three months we were locked up for. We couldn't do anything with him, and he actually got strangles and was the last horse to get a clearance and he didn't get cleared until December. He's back now, on all cylinders. We were happy with him up in Queensland, but it just kept on raining. His work was compromised up there, but the good thing is he's had that time away in the sun. I don't think I've seen him trial better than that."

Oliveanotherday impresses Dabernig

Another to impress at Wednesday morning's Caulfield Heath jumpouts was the Tom Dabernig-trained Oliveanotherday (Nicconi), working nicely in a 1000-metre heat alongside other spring contenders. The four-year-old gelding has won five of his seven career starts, including his last four, and was last sighted landing the Wangoom Handicap (Listed, 1200m) at Warrnambool on May 6. "I think potentially he could be top class," Dabernig told Michael Felgate on The Verdict. "But there's no test like the racetrack and he's got to keep taking those next steps. Very happy [with the workout]. He probably came back in his trial a little more switched on this time round. He's a four-year-old, but he's still relatively lightly raced. Today it was great to see him use that big action just on a nice surface."

Mr Miller makes his mark at Warwick Farm

Talented four-year-old Mr Miller (Almanzor) lived up to his lofty reputation with an effortless victory over 1400 metres at Warwick Farm on Wednesday, prompting connections to dream of more ambitious spring targets. The son of Almanzor (Wootton Bassett) was sent out the \$1.28 favourite for the BenchMark 72 (1400m) contest and the Chris Waller-trained gelding scored by two and a half lengths in the hands of James McDonald. "He is obviously a classy individual," Waller's assistant trainer Charlie Duckworth said. "He has taken a bit of time to mentally work it all out, and I still think there is further improvement in that department. He is a highly progressive horse and has a very bright future. In the actual race I thought he behaved beautifully, but it's all about the trimmings around the edges. He knocked over a strapper last Friday and he can be a bit of a lad at times. We will work it out, and as we get a bit deeper into the prep it will take a bit of fizz out of him, and he will make it to a decent level."

Smith's mare set for Princess Series

Queen's Gamble (Anders) will next head to the Tea Rose Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) following her dominant success at Warwick Farm on Wednesday. The Matthew Smith-trained filly broke her maiden at the fourth attempt in the Inglis Xtra Bonus Handicap (1300m), defeating Satin Serenade (Frankel) by 2.5 lengths under Tommy Berry as an \$8 chance. "At this time of year, you've nearly got to have a crack at them if they're going well like that, and she's progressive," Smith said. "The Tea Rose, it's about four weeks away, which is perfect. The fact Tommy stayed with her is a big plus because he sits on a lot of nice horses and he could have easily jumped onto something else. The fact he stayed on, I thought, there's a bit more in the tank than what we're seeing. He was confident when she got over a little bit further, she'd be better, and we've definitely bumped into a couple of handy ones [at her previous starts]."

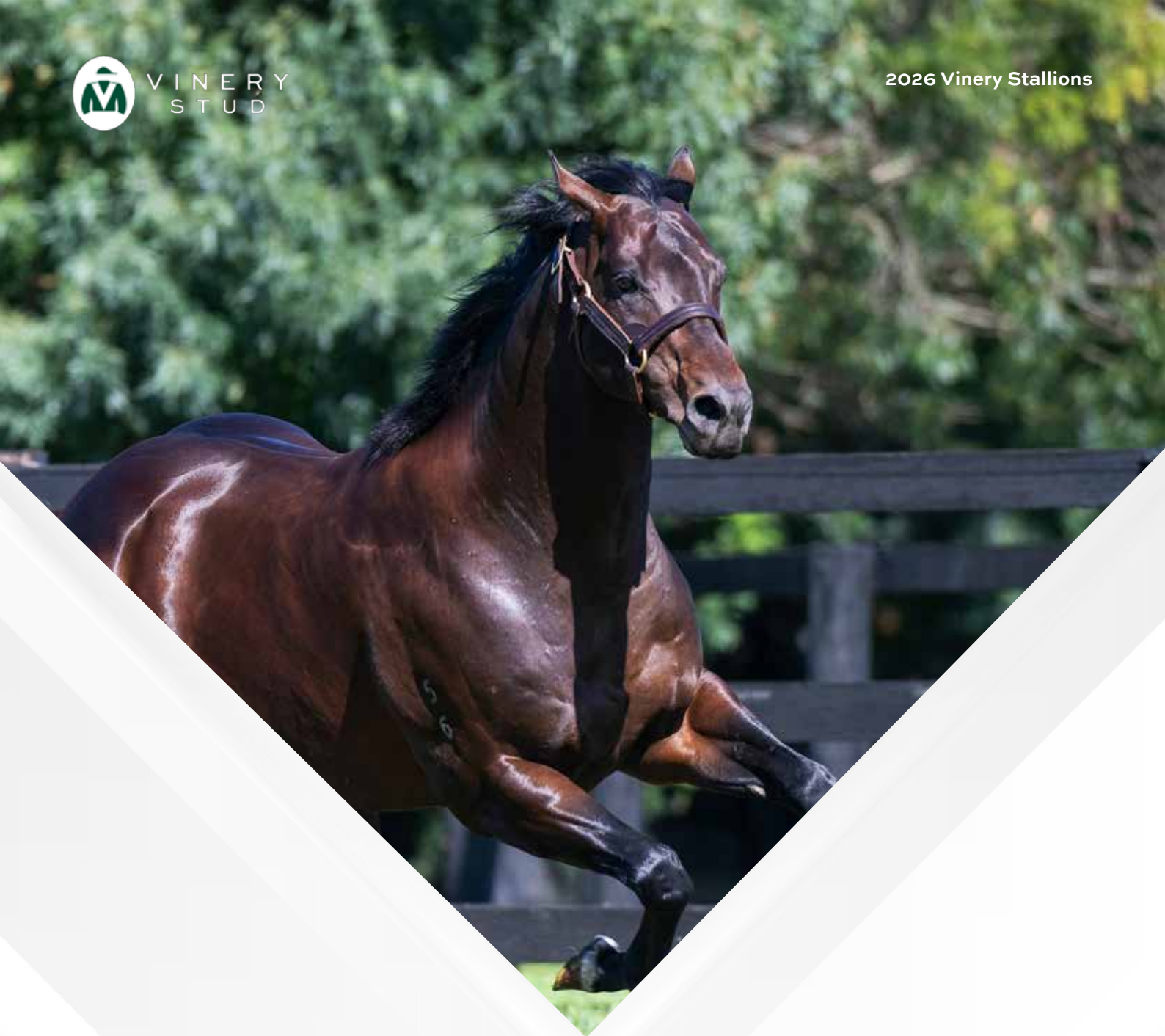
Maher has first four home in Sandown contest

A race at Sandown-Lakeside on Wednesday saw Ciaran Maher send home the first four runners. The quartet returned just over \$1200 for a \$1



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unit in the Sportsbet Fixed Odds Exotics Plate (1200m), with the Jabez Johnstone-ridden Saintry Dancer (St Mark's Basilica) scored by a half-length over Ghana's Akan (Street Boss). Platinum Pearl (Frankel) finished a further 0.7 lengths behind in third, while Stipulation (Frankel) rounded out the four, beaten three lengths by the winner. "To the whole stable's credit, they have run out of all three locations in this race," Maher's assistant trainer Jack Turnbull said. "She [Saintry Dancer] has taken a little management early days, always hot and active, but the Ballarat team has done a terrific job. We were chatting pre-race, and depending on how she went, would determine where we go, but the fact that she has won, and beat Ghana's Akan, it sets us up to have a look at some better races in the next couple of weeks. She was purchased to get further, but 1400 metres, a mile, may be a question mark this time in, but we'll just train the horse. We'll let her tell us, even if we get her at the back end of spring, there is a lot of quality."

Chariot charges to Sandown triumph

Progressive four-year-old Gold Chariot (Circus Maximus) continued his rise through the grades with an impressive victory over 1600 metres at Sandown-Lakeside on Wednesday. Trained by Mick Price and Michael Kent Jnr, the son of Circus Maximus (Galileo) produced a sustained finishing effort under Blake Shinn to overcome a race shape that was firmly against him and score in Benchmark 66 company by 1.3 lengths. "It was a good win in the end. It was not where we wanted to be," Kent Jnr said. "Blake looked up and saw five wide inside of him and he came back. Of course, as they always do, they backed it off and there were 13-second sectionals mid-race. I thought we'd be in trouble with the way the track has played. He was 12 lengths off them, but in a matter of strides he picked them up. It was a most impressive win. He's a beautiful horse and I'm rapt for all the owners. He's a nice horse for the future."

Marsh stablemates in zone for Foxbridge

Resuming runners Media World (Written Tycoon) and Tardelli (I Am Invincible) are primed for bold first-up displays in Saturday's Foxbridge Plate (Gr2, 1200m) ahead of sterner spring tests. The Stephen Marsh-trained pair have trialled encouragingly ahead of the Waikato Stud-sponsored feature at Te Rapa, with Matthew Cartwright and Kyle Wilson-Taylor respectively booked to partner the duo. Safely through the weekend, they will both head to the Proisir Plate (Gr 1, 1400m) at Ellerslie on September 5 in which they will be joined by glamour mare Well Written (Written Tycoon). "She came through her trial at Taupo brilliantly and we'll take her up to Ellerslie on Thursday week for a light gallop. I can't fault her at all," Marsh said of Well Written. Like her unbeaten stablemate, Media World runs in the colours of powerhouse Australian-based operation Yulong. "They've obviously got half of Well Written and Media World and we've also got Hidden Achievement, an I Am Invincible colt who will trial on Saturday before the

first at Te Rapa, and a Super Seth two-year-old colt for them," Marsh said. Tardelli hasn't raced since the summer and finished third behind Alabama Lass (Alabama Express) and Media World in a recent open heat at Te Rapa. "He trialled very well and has come back so well for this preparation," Marsh said. "I loved the way he attacked the line and Kyle was very impressed with his trial, he said he's flying."

43 for Frankel

Juddmonte stallion Frankel (Galileo) sired his 43rd individual Group 1 winner on Wednesday when Item (3 c ex Capla Temptress by Lope De Vega) landed the International Stakes (Gr 1, 1m 2.5f) at York. In a race sponsored by both his and his sire's owner-breeder Juddmonte, the Andrew Balding-trained colt stayed on strongly down the centre of the track inside the final furlong to collar Almaqam (Lope De Vega) on the line to score by a head under Colin Keane. There was a further three and a half lengths back to Constitution River (Wootton Bassett) in third place, with last year's returning winner Ombudsman (Night Of Thunder) back in fourth. Wednesday's win was Item's third at York from as many outings at the track. "He's a specialist around here, he seems to love it. I was never really comfortable, the gap closed in front of us at a crucial point but he battled well to get back up. I was surprised Ryan [Moore] was as close as he was, but his horse jumped and travelled well. It wasn't until William [Buick] came to me that Item got going. The last 50 yards, I thought I'd get a chance to get Kieran. The rain was a bit of a worry, but it's fresh ground." A half-brother to Listed winner Temptable (Kingman), Item is the third foal out of the Grade 1-winning Lope De Vega (Shamardal) mare Capla Temptress. Frankel stood the 2026 northern hemisphere breeding season at Banstead Manor Stud for a fee of £350,000 (approx. AU\$669,030).

68 for Justify

Haffner (2 c ex Earth Strike by Zoffany) became the 68th individual stakes winner for Coolmore's former shuttler Justify (Scat Daddy) when comfortably scoring in Wednesday's Acomb Stakes (Gr 3, 7f) at York. Ridden by Ryan Moore, the juvenile colt went one place better than for

his last-start runner-up finish in the Vintage Stakes (Gr 2, 7f) as he defeated Gentle Hurricane (Invincible Spirit) by two lengths. There was a further half-length back to the third-placed Trean (Bayside Boy) in third. Bred by DJ Stables & Justify Syndicate, Haffner was purchased for US\$375,000 by M V Magnier and White Birch Farm at the 2025 Keeneland September Yearling Sale and is raced by Peter Brant, Coolmore, Westerberg, and Brook Smith. He is a half-brother to winner Orbit (Medaglia D'Oro) being the second foal out of the winning Zoffany (Dansili) mare Earth Strike, herself a half-sister to multiple Group 1 winner Order Of St George (Galileo) and Group/Graded scorers Asperity (War Chant) and Angel Terrace (Ghostzapper). Justify stood the 2026 northern hemisphere breeding season Ashford Stud for a fee of US\$200,000 (approx. AU\$280,940).

UK: Maltese Cross continues upward curve in Great Voltigeur

The William Haggas-trained Maltese Cross (3 c Sea The Stars - Nabatea by Camelot)

added a second Group success to his CV when landing Wednesday's Great Voltigeur Stakes (Gr 2, 1m 4f) at York. Ridden by Tom Marquand, the Sea The Stars (Cape Cross) colt followed up his last-start Grand Prix de Paris (Gr 1, 2400m) victory with a gutsy two-length defeat of Pierre Bonnard (Camelot) in this Group 2 event. There was a further two and a quarter lengths back to Epsom Derby (Gr 1, 1m 4f) hero Christmas Day (Camelot) in third place.

UK: Asfoora to face 17 rivals in defence of Nunthorpe

Henry Dwyer's star mare Asfoora (Flying Artie) will face 17 rivals after being declared to defend her title in Friday's Nunthorpe Stakes (Gr 1, 5f) at York. The three-time Group 1 scorer will tackle Wesley Ward's colt Bacio (Maclean's Music), who bolted up in the Palace Of Holyroodhouse Handicap (5f) at Royal Ascot in June. French raider Rayevka (Blue Point), who was second in the King Charles III Stakes (Gr 1, 5f) at the royal

meeting, will take her chance for Francis Graffard, while American Affair (Washington DC) and Rumstar (Havana Grey), the first two runners home in the King George Stakes (Gr 2, 5f) at Glorious Goodwood, will also take their place in the 18-runner field.

FR: Rashabar to stand at Castillon Stallions in 2027

Coventry Stakes (Gr 2, 6f) winner Rashabar (Holy Roman Emperor) will stand at Castillon Stallions in France for the 2027 breeding season. Trained by Brian Meehan, the Manton Thoroughbreds-owned colt also ran close seconds in the Prix Morny (Gr 1, 1200m) and Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere (Gr 1, 1400m). "I am delighted that Sam Sangster and his partners have chosen us ahead of several studs in Britain," Benoit Jeffroy, founder of Castillon Stallions, said. "Rashabar's race record and physical make him a very attractive commercial prospect. There is also a strong support programme behind the horse, with both his owners and Castillon firmly committed to him."

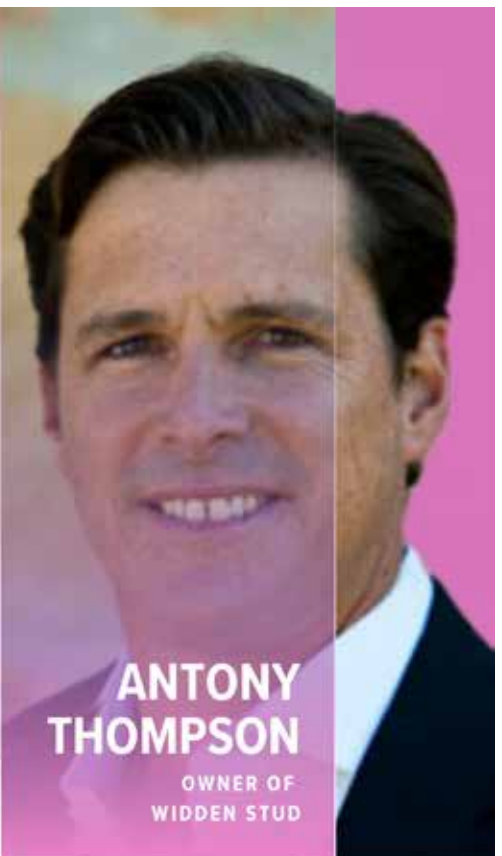
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It's In The Blood

Hard Kick

A mare who just wouldn't go away has rewarded Macquarie Stud's David Baxter in handsome style, with her son Hard Kick (All Too Hard) winning his second black type race in last Saturday's prestigious Vain Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m).

The Caulfield three-year-old dash won in recent years by the likes of Sepoy (Elusive Quality), Bivouac (Exceed And Excel) and Giga Kick (Scissor Kick) went the way of the Hayes brothers' gelding in fighting style, two runs after his debut victory in Flemington's Talindert Stakes (Listed, 1100m).

And, as with several previous Vain winners, it has served notice of a strong career ahead, especially if his trainers are any guide.

From a modest family, Hard Kick was sold at the Magic Millions Adelaide Yearling Sale on behalf of Macquarie for \$30,000, bought by Avesta Bloodstock. He was then onsold as a two-year-old at the Inglis Ready To Race sale for \$140,000 to the Hayes boys.

"He was always a very good type, and we decided to send him to Adelaide because we thought he might stand out a bit there," Baxter tells *It's In The Blood*. "We put \$30,000 on him, and that's what he fetched.

"He went to the Ready To Race sale and apparently he trialled very well. From memory he ran the fastest breeze-up before the sale and that's when the Hayes boys stepped in and bought him."

Lindsay Park remained his sole owner. Baxter was no longer directly involved but still had a deep interest, which he followed up out of concern the colt might be packed off to the brothers' father David in Hong Kong, like a certain other Hayes family transfer named Ka Ying Rising (Shamexpress).

"I asked them along the way what the plans were, because we were getting second hand

stories he'd be off to Hong Kong," Baxter said. "One of the boys - and I'm not sure which one I was talking to - said, 'We own him and we train him and that's the great advantage which means we can do what we like, and we'll win the Coolmore with him.

"I said, 'That sounds very good to me."

It's odds-on the "little smiley bloke" to whom Baxter refers was JD Hayes, the chirpiest of the younger twins. What's known for sure is Hard Kick is on the third line of betting for the Coolmore Stud Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m), and a win there would cap a remarkable turnaround in fortunes for his dam, Friendly Donna (Exceed And Excel).

Baxter took Friendly Donna to Inglis Easter 2013 for a client, but liked her so much he bought her, having also been closely acquainted with Exceed And Excel (Daneshill) through his career.

"I thought she was worth about \$100,000, and that's what I paid for her. I wasn't going any higher," Baxter says.

Turf lore is littered with stories of such bold purchases that bring great rewards for a person's insight and judgment. This isn't one of them.

"I had a lot to do with Exceed And Excel," Baxter says. "Clients of mine bought him as a yearling, and I followed him on the track and at stud.

"This filly had the right backside for an Exceed And Excel, so I bought her on type, having had so much experience with him and his progeny.

"But, saying all that, she couldn't gallop."

Despite being out of a Sydney city winning mare in Donna Intelligente (Dehere), Friendly Donna had five starts in the bush and couldn't conjure a placing. She was retired after her personal bests of fourths at Bathurst and Mudgee, with \$1,450 in the bank - just \$98,550 shy of Baxter's outlay.

"She didn't have it," Baxter says. "She was given the opportunity but was pretty slow, but being such a good type, and having the right pedigree, it was worth giving her a shot at breeding."

And then, from this humble beginning - still not much happened.

Friendly Donna's filly first foal Tir (Shooting To Win) had one start for Baxter, running 14th at Dubbo. That was still more than her second foal could boast, since he didn't make it to the track at all.

Then Baxter ventured to Vinery Stud's ultra-consistent producer All Too Hard (Casino Prince). Friendly Donna threw Harderthantherest, a filly who at least won four bush races from 24 starts.

In 2020, Baxter had had enough. He tried to sell Friendly Donna - not once but twice - in-foal to Darley newcomer Harry Angel (Dark Angel), but he failed. The mare was passed in both times.

She had that Harry Angel foal - O'Donna - who fetched \$85,000 as a yearling but also didn't have it, being packed off after four unplaced runs.

Baxter tried to offload his mare again in 2021, in-foal again to All Too Hard, at Inglis's Sydney Broodmare Sale, but again she came back home with him.

"Jeez, I must have been rich in those days," the breeder says with a laugh. "We were taking mares to sales, but I clearly couldn't get what I wanted for her. It's funny how it works out. She kinda stuck to me."

Friendly Donna had that All Too Hard foal - deceased - and Baxter scratched his head, wondering what to do with his mare.

She wasn't covered in 2021, but the following year he tried All Too Hard again. Finally, 13 years after he bought her, Friendly Donna has delivered some good news in the form of Hard Kick.

The mare subsequently slipped a foal by Cosmic Force (Deep Field), and with her record still very modest, Baxter didn't get around to putting her to a stallion last year.

Now that Hard Kick has appeared, she won't be having the coming spring off, however. Not only is Baxter these days content to hang onto her, he's now keen on a mating from Newgate Farm up-and-comer Stay Inside (Extreme Choice).

In the meantime, he'll be following Hard Kick closely.

"He was a good looking yearling," he said. "He was possibly a bit plain about the head. He was a typical All Too Hard, with a bit of a Roman nose, a bit of that coming through Casino Prince.

"But he was a very well made horse and a good moving horse, and he looks nice and tough now.

There are dashes of black type deeper into Hard Kick's family.

Second dam Donna Intelligente was a half-sister to two black type winners including Burning Sands (Marju), who won a Sweet Embrace Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m).

And third dam Encarta (Our Westminster) was a winning half-sister to Skoozi (Prince Of Praise), who won in New Zealand, Australia and the UAE, claiming two Melbourne Group 2s in the Liston Stakes (1400m) and Carlyon Cup (1600m) and a Group 3 sprint in Dubai. He also placed in four Group 1s.

Encarta was the last of eight straight New Zealand mares on the tail female line including Hard Kick's sixth dam, the outstanding Jandell (Shifnal). In the mid-70s, Jandell won six modern Group races from 2000m to 2400m including Randwick's Queen Elizabeth Stakes, back when it was a mile and a half.

Baxter says there was "no great science" about putting Friendly Donna to All Too Hard, though the physicals matched well.

But the mating does represent one of All Too Hard's finest nicks. The 17-year-old - standing this year at an unchanged \$27,500 - has had two stakes winners from 12 runners out of Exceed And Excel mares, at 16 per cent. That's his best nick of more than 11 runners, though Hussonet (Mr Prospector) sits just below him on the list with two black type victors from 11 runners at 18 per cent.

Hard Kick's pedigree thumbs the nose again at double Danehill doubters. He owns both sirelines in a 4m x 3m duplication, despite two sons being statistically slightly the worst of the three double Danehill combinations.

His son Flying Spur is All Too Hard's grandsire, while down below Danehill is Exceed And Excel's father.

Danehill's sire Danzig (Northern Dancer) is repeated at 5m, 5m x 5m, the middle one being Green Desert, grandsire of All Too Hard's (and Black Caviar's) dam Helsing (Desert Sun).

And Danzig's sire Northern Dancer (Nearctic) comes in strong with eight appearances including six in the first six generations - 6m, 6m, 6m x 5m, 5m, 6m via four different sons, the non-Danzigs being Try My Best, Lomond and Vice Regent.

Danehill is the top blood contributor with 18.75 per cent, from Northern Dancer (14.06 per cent) and Danzig (12.5 per cent).

Blue hen Natalma (Native Dancer) is next, heading up the females with 9.38 per cent thanks to ten appearances, while 1920s Italian mare Nogara (Havresac) also has ten spots deeper in.

Those two great breed-shapers Nearco (Pharos) and Hyperion (Gainsborough) share the most common stallion honours, with 16 appearances each.

She couldn't pick her feet up on the track, and she should probably have ended up somewhere else by now, but Friendly Donna has, as her name suggests, ultimately proven a good mare for Baxter to have by his side.
