Munz hoping for black-type cash in with Global Goal

Jonathan Munz is eagerly anticipating pulling the covers off the latest starlet from his Shoals (Fastnet Rock) family when Global Goal (Pinatubo) opens a spring of great promise in a talent-packed Silver Shadow Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m).

Munz, via his GSA Bloodstock holding, bred the filly in conjunction with his frequent partner John Messara of Arrowfield Stud before buying her outright when she went to auction at Inglis Easter, for \$250,000.

The pair, who co-own Global Goal's dam Tides (Fastnet Rock), her star full-sister Shoals and their dam The Broken Shore (Hussonet) among others, like to engage in a friendly rivalry after one buys the other out. Munz has had some highly encouraging events to chirp about in his texts to Messara on this one.

Munz, the heavyweight Melbourne owner-breeder, sent Global Goal to Randwick's John Sargent - continuing a line of females he's placed with the renowned fillies conditioner including stakes winners Four Moves Ahead (Snitzel) and Emeralds

Continued from page 2 (Sebring), and the stakes-placed Inevitable Truth (Fastnet Rock).

The well-bred filly has upheld her end of the bargain so far as she sets out to build on a fair beginning for Darley's young shuttler Pinatubo (Shamardal).

For her only start to date, she was sent south-west for the rich Inglis Challenge (1200m) on Wagga Cup day. Drifting from \$5 to \$7 for the unsuitably short trip, she was noticeably roused along by Dylan Gibbons under great pressure around the 600m but mustered a powerful finish to score by 1.3 lengths. The second horse, Friendly Fire (Farnan) won his next outing at Randwick and ran second at Rosehill the start after.

After spelling for more development, Global Goal produced almost a carbon copy in her second barrier trial at Rosehill on August 7 - scrubbed along and looking forlorn at the 600m, before building a late burst to run a 0.73-length second.

She's now "thrown in at the deep end" at Randwick on Saturday, Munz says, as she takes on a range of speedy three-year-old fillies who showed quality in the autumn in the Silver Shadow's ten-horse field, seven of whom are resuming.

Agrarian Girl (Tassort), a \$3.90 favourite on Friday, reflected all the pace of her sire on debut, leading throughout in the Waterhouse-Bott way to lift the Lonhro Plate (Listed, 1000m). She then tried it again when stepped up a furlong in the Reisling Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m), but faded into a 2.97-length third.

Tony Gollan's second favourite Pembrey (Prague) won over both 1000 metres on debut at Eagle Farm and over six furlongs at start three in Rosehill's Magic Night Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m)

before finishing down the track from a wide barrier in the Golden Slipper (Gr 1, 1200m).

And Team Archibald's Cherry Bomshell (Lucky Vega) won her last three starts before a spell, twice at Eagle Farm over 1000 metres, then when stepped up in Randwick's Percy Sykes Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m).

With abundant speed up front, the race should set up well for \$10 chance Global Goal if, as expected, Gibbons lets her settle near the rear from gate five with her minimum 55 kilograms in the set weights and penalties event.

Munz isn't anticipating victory - he's not hailing Global Goal as the next version of her Aunty Shoals just yet - but expect to see his red and white stripes making inroads at the finish as the filly begins a campaign in which she could become his latest elite winner at a longer trip, with the Flight Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) her likely first such target.

"This is a big jump in class that Sarg has given her," Munz told ANZ Bloodstock News. "But bigger risk, bigger reward. **Continued on page 4**

Continued from page 3 “She’s had one start for one win, and won impressively. She’s from one of our best families, so we want to get black type with her. You’d be happy to get small black type and see how she goes.

“But we’ll find out how good she is. It’s a pretty hot field. A lot of those other horses are proper speed horses from the autumn. You’ve got a Percy Sykes winner in there, and things that were stakes-placed in the lead-up to the Slipper. So they’re good horses.

“She’s not Shoals, but this will be a good benchmark for where she’s at.”

Munz would of course be overjoyed if Global Goal could eventually earn comparison to Shoals, Australia’s Champion 3YO Filly of 2017-19, and the equal leading older female on the 2018 World Thoroughbred Rankings for sprinters.

The Anthony Freedman-trained star - this time co-raced by Munz and Messara - won three Group 1s from 1200 metres to 1600 metres, and took the Percy Sykes as well among six black type victories.

She’s since thrown for the two JMs another stakes winner in Flemington Group 3 victor Isthmus (I Am Invincible).

Shoals was the first foal for The Broken Shore. He third was another full-sibling in Groundswell (Fastnet Rock), the gelding who won an Adelaide Listed and placed third in the 2019 Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m), won by another who carried Munz’s silks with distinction in current Coolmore sire Super Seth (Dundeel).

In between the two came Tides, Global Goal’s dam, who won thrice from eight starts

for Freedman including once over 1600 metres at Sandown.

“Tides had black type ability but got injured,” Munz said. “But she was less brilliant than Shoals, so you would think Global Goal is a miler, although she did win pretty well over 1200 [metres].

“We’re still finding out about her really. You can’t tell how good she is yet. But if she can get any black type at all, obviously that adds a lot of value to her, especially from that family.”

With The Broken Shore being out of Shantha’s Choice (Canny Lad), Global Goal will be the second filly to step out at Randwick in eight days with that great blue hen as her third dam.

Last Saturday featured Bjorn Baker’s Blue Door (Stay Inside), who in fact has Shantha’s

Choice at 5m x 3f thanks to her famed son Redoute’s Choice (Danehill) on her top line. Blue Door did it the other way to Global Goal, leading in quest of a second stakes win from as many starts in Rosehill’s The Rosebud (Listed, 1100m), but being collared late in a 0.98-length second.

While he’s always seeking to cultivate another highly valuable gem for his broodmare band, Munz is also loath to tempt the gods by getting ahead of himself.

But the obvious suite of elite races to consider for Global Goal are the spring fillies’ miles of the Flight Stakes at Randwick on October 3 and Caulfield’s Thousand Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) two weeks later, and the Empire Rose Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) for fillies and mares in Cup week.

"The fact her jockey was getting busy at the 600 [metres], in her race and in her last barrier trial, tells you she's probably going to be better at a bit longer," Munz said.

"The Flight Stakes - in your dreams. You don't start talking about a Flight Stakes until they've done something. If she runs eighth on Saturday, beaten ten lengths, she's not going to win the Flight Stakes. If she motors home for fifth beaten a length-and-a-half, she could be a stakes horse.

"Your cohort of races if you're a filly miler are the Flight, the Thousand Guineas and the Empire Rose.

"But really, you just want black type, the easiest black type you can get to start with, and then progress further.

"In the spring, there's not that much easy black type in the lead-ups to the main races. You can get cheaper black type at the end of spring, but there's no easy races in the Sydney or Melbourne spring.

"We'll take any black type to start with, and then dream on if she progresses and is showing something."

Global Goal would give a push to the nine-year-old Pinatubo if she can perform during his fifth spring at Darley, in which he'll stand for \$27,500 (inc GST), down from \$38,500. That reflects a situation in which breeders may be waiting for the other shoe to drop with the stallion, and a hope by Darley that after a promising first season of runners, his progeny might especially blossom at three.

Pinatubo was Champion 2YO Colt in Europe, Britain and Ireland after two Group 1 wins, but also the equal leading 3YO male on the 2020 WTR for 1600 metres after picking up his third Group 1.

He finished a highly commendable second on the Australia's first season sires' chart last term by earnings, but fifth on winners, with five from 26 runners.

Pinatubo had one stakes winner in Voynichese, who took a Brisbane Listed over 1500 metres, but with three black type placegetters including Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) fourth placegetter Zambales, he was close to achieving grandly.

Munz and Messara sent Tides to Pinatubo for his first season in Australia to breed Global Goal. Part of the motivation was to replicate the cross of his sire Shamardal (Giant's Causeway) over Tides' father Fastnet Rock (Daneshill), seen to great effect in the Freedman-trained Santa Ana Lane (Lope De Vega, by Shamardal), a five-time Group 1 winner from 1200-1400 metres.

Shamardal over Fastnet Rock was only tried twice and yielded a Group winner. But one son of his - Lope De Vega - over Fastnet Rock runs at 23 per cent stakes winners to runners, with five from 21 including two elite victors - Santa Ana Lane and Gytrash. It's Lope De Vega's finest nick of more than 11 runners.

"The cross had worked, and Pinatubo was a promising young stallion who was a champion on the track," Munz says.

"I think he's started ok. I look at him and I say, 'He's not a bad stallion'. It's early days - a little bit like his daughter in this case."

Layzell calls for release of Hazzard Report

NSW NATIONALS

NSW Shadow Minister for Racing Dave Layzell has added his voice to calls for Racing Minister David Harris to release the Hazzard Report

into the Thoroughbred Racing Act 1996. The review, led by former NSW Liberal leader and racing minister Brad Hazzard, was handed to the NSW Government in July following submissions from a broad cross-section of industry participants. "The NSW Government's review into the Thoroughbred Racing Act 1996, otherwise known as the Hazzard Review, was handed to Minister Harris in July, it is time it was made public," Layzell said. "Many important participants in the industry made significant and detailed submissions into the review - they deserve to see the report." Layzell noted there are six sitting weeks remaining before both houses of NSW Parliament rise ahead of the March 2027 state election and urged the Government not to delay its release.

"Racing is about more than Randwick and Rosehill," he said. "Country race clubs from the Murrumbidgee to Murwillumbah want to know what the state government can do to assist them to be sustainable and ensure thriving local racing industries."

Winx return key for Idle Flyer

Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) aspirant Idle Flyer (Dundeel) will line up in Saturday's Winx Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) as the mare kicks off against some of the best in the business. A winner of the Queen Of The Turf Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) in the autumn, Idle Flyer will face the likes of Autumn Glow (The Autumn Sun), Sheza Alibi (Saxon Warrior), Aeliana (Castelvecchio) and Ceolwulf

(Tavistock) in this weekend's Group 1, and her trainer Matthew Smith is hoping she can put up a decent starting effort. "She's not going to beat those horses in a 1400 metre race, so it's really a starting point for her," Smith said. "She'll just get better and better into her preparation once she gets to a mile and beyond. But I'm really keen to see where she fits in. She's had a trouble free 'prep' leading into the run. Her fitness is good, and she handles a wet track, so she'll run really well."

Prima Bella readied for Randwick

Matthew Smith will also run Prima Bella (Per Incanto) in Saturday's Toy Show Quality (Gr 3, 1100m) at Randwick, with the mare chasing a hat-trick of victories following wins in Benchmark 78 (1000m) and Benchmark 88 (1000m) contests at Flemington and Randwick on her last two outings. "I thought, if she won the other day you've got to have a crack at a mares' race," Smith said. "It might be too tough

for her, but she's going well. She's race fit. She's ready, and she'll roll forward. If she can run top four, I'll be delighted."

Berry backs Apocalyptic in Toy Show Quality

Tommy Berry is hoping that Apocalyptic (Extreme Choice) can put up a bold effort when she takes to Randwick for the Toy Show Quality. The Michael Freedman trained daughter of Extreme Choice (Not A Single Doubt) produced an excellent three-year-old season, winning the Flight Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) and two further Group 2s while also placing in the Thousand Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) and running fourth in the Surround Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m). She returns from a break this weekend and proved herself in good form when beating subsequent The Rosebud (Listed, 1100m) winner Chilly Girl (Trapeze Artist) in a 900-metre barrier trial at Rosehill on August 7. "She's had a really good break, very similar to Ninja," Berry said. "Michael

The four-year-old mare landed an 1100 metre handicap at Caulfield two starts ago on July 11 before then running fourth last time out back at the same track. She will head for the Carlyon Stakes (Gr 3, 1000m) at Sandown on Saturday bidding to add to four career wins from 11 starts. "The trip is a big plus and she likes soft ground," Maher's assistant trainer Jack Turnbull said. "And she's had four weeks in between runs this time. We thought she didn't run to her best last start because we ran her back a bit quick. She was physically fine, but she was first up off a 10 week let up and went back [to the races] after two weeks which is a hard thing to do. It's a bit of a reprieve, four weeks into this. She's not in great at the weights, but her quality gives her the chance to be competitive."

Nearco Frod chasing four straight wins

Having run up a hat-trick of wins in a Benchmark 84 (2520m) at Flemington last time out, the Tony and Calvin McEvoy trained Nearco Frod (Hunter's Light) will bid to make it four successive victories when he lines up in the McMahon's Dairy Handicap (2400m) at Sandown on Saturday. Tony McEvoy revealed that a start in the Caulfield Cup (Gr 1, 2400m) was the dream for five-year-old gelding, but a run in The Archer (Gr 3, 2500m) could be the plan in a bid to gain a ballot exemption into November's Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m). "He'll go to The Archer and then we'll reassess where we are then," McEvoy said. "The Caulfield Cup, it is a big step, but we've put him in and he's a handy little stayer. We saw last year where they can come from, but at this stage we're thinking Saturday and then into The Archer."

Local cups on agenda for Sir Kingsford

The Gary and Nichole Searle and Brianna Callana trained Sir Kingsford (Sir Prancealot) is being prepared for three upcoming local cups and will begin his spring campaign in Saturday's Leon Macdonald Stakes (Listed, 1400m) at Morphettville. This weekend's race is being used as a lead up into the Balaklava Cup (Listed, 1600m) on September 16, the Murray Bridge Cup (Listed, 1600m) on October 3 and the John Letts Cup (Listed, 1800m) back at Morphettville on Melbourne Cup Day. "He was bouncing, so we thought we would bring him in," Gary Searle said. "We'll run him in this, which he will probably need, but in saying that, he has a bit of a spring in his step, the old fella, so I don't think he will disgrace himself. After this, we'll go to the Balaklava Cup, the Murray Bridge Cup and the John Letts Cup. We went through that last year. We ran third in the Murray Bridge Cup and second to Air Assault in the John Letts Cup. Air Assault has got the wood on us up to 1800 [metres], but maybe he might end up in Melbourne this year. He's going to running in races that are going to be short of his best, but I'll treat him a bit different this prep as I won't be getting out past 2000 metres."

Michael Moroney new target for Lara Antipova

Previously unbeaten filly Lara Antipova's (Russian Revolution) spring campaign will change tack slightly following her first career defeat in last Saturday's Quezette Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) at Caulfield. The daughter of Russian Revolution (Snitzel) was an unstoppable force in New Zealand last season, winning all four of her starts, including the Sistema Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m), and the decision was made for her to join Te Akau's Cranbourne barn to test her talent in Australia this spring. However, she wasn't given any favours in her Australian debut, lumbered with 59 kilograms and forced to race three and four wide, and she was held up in the latter stages of the race, finishing ninth. Initially set to head to the Thousand Guineas Prelude (Gr 2, 1400m) at Caulfield on September 19, trainer Mark Walker has elected to change tack in search of weight relief, and she will now line up at Flemington a week prior. "We

will go to a new race called the Mike Moroney [Listed, 1400m] on the 12th of September, and it's against the colts and geldings at set weights and penalties, but she will carry 57.5kg because she gets that two kilo filly allowance," he said. "If she went really well, she will go to the Bill Stutt Stakes, and that's when she gets back to set weights racing, which will help."

Roselyn's Star takes out star studded trial

The John O'Shea and Tom Charlton-trained sprinter Roselyn's Star (Shalaa) took out a star studded trial at Rosehill on Friday. Lining up in the 900-metre heat under Chad Schofield, the five-year-old gelding defeated last-start Concorde Stakes (Gr 3, 1000m) winner Headwall (Dream Ahead) by 3.1 lengths, while Golden Slipper (Gr 1, 1200m) and The Galaxy (Gr 1, 1100m) winner Marhoona (Snitzel) was having her second trial and ran just a further 0.1 lengths behind in third place. The trial also saw Skyhook (Written Tycoon) (fourth), Beadman (Snitzel) (fifth), Lazzura (Snitzel) (sixth), Linebacker (Super Seth) (seventh), Militarize (Dundeel) (eighth), and Kovalica (Ocean Park) (ninth) have a run out.

The Valley to pass expectations before racing return

Racing Victoria CEO Aaron Morrison has revealed that there will be no automatic return to racing at the redeveloped Moonee Valley, with the club required to satisfy a number of expectations before the venue comes back online. "We do have some clear expectations of Moonee Valley before they are fit to return to racing," Morrison told Michael Felgate on The Verdict. "So there's no automatic assumption that they're just going to do what they need to do and re-resume racing under any circumstance."

ATC builds new infield precinct at Randwick

The 2026 Sydney Everest Carnival is breaking all ticket sale records, with a looming sell-out on TAB Everest Day forcing the Australian Turf Club (ATC) to expand crowd capacity for the world's richest race on turf. Corporate hospitality for TAB Everest Day is already sold

out across the racecourse, prompting a new 1,000 person capacity premium hospitality venue, the TAB Clubhouse, going on sale. TAB Clubhouse, a joint ATC, Racing NSW and TAB initiative, will offer corporate hospitality with elevated views along the home straight, adjacent to the Randwick winning post. ATC CEO Steve McMahon said: "This is just the beginning. TAB Clubhouse is more than a new venue, it's a statement about where we're heading. As the TAB Everest continues to grow, we'll keep investing in new precincts, new experiences and new ways to bring more people closer to the action at Royal Randwick."

New Zealand

NZTR and TAB NZ finalise industry funding package

New Zealand Thoroughbred Racing (NZTR) and TAB NZ have finalised a revised funding package for the 2026/27 racing season. The agreement follows constructive engagement between the two organisations. While NZTR and TAB NZ began some distance apart, both parties worked hard to reach a responsible outcome within a more constrained funding environment. NZTR board chairman Paul Humphries said the agreement reflected a shared commitment to achieving the best available outcome for the Thoroughbred racing industry. "There has been considerable work by the NZTR management team and Board, alongside TAB NZ, to reach this position," Humphries said. "We acknowledge the process took longer than anticipated and thank industry participants for their patience and support. Finalising the package enables NZTR to confirm its budgets and gives clubs and participants greater certainty to plan for the season ahead."

Under the revised arrangements:

- TAB NZ's base funding allocation to NZTR for 2026/27 will increase from \$110 million to \$118 million. This includes \$3 million brought forward from the 2027/28 racing year.
- TAB NZ is no longer funding the Summer Carnival stakes through the Rejuvenation Fund (this was \$8m in FY25 and \$7m in FY26).
- Stakes and bonus funding will be budgeted at \$104 million for the season.
- TAB NZ will fund the OnTrack programme

directly, rather than through NZTR as it has for the past year.

- A further \$3.6 million in proposed track infrastructure investment will be considered separately through the Establishment Board's funding process. Additional funding to progress the RACE Awapuni and Waikato Thoroughbred Racing Greenfields projects will also be considered separately through this process. None of this expenditure will form part of NZTR's operating budget.

On-course trainer David Greene's optimism has grown as the week has progressed, with Te Rapa's track improving into the Soft range ahead of Saturday's Waikato Stud Foxbridge Plate meeting. The Hamilton horseman's Group 1 winning sprinter First Five (Almanzor) is set to resume in the Foxbridge Plate (Gr 2, 1200m) this weekend, with the gelding reliant on better footing. The six-year-old son of Almanzor (Wootton Bassett) has yet to line up on a Heavy track, and Greene said he wasn't about to change that this weekend, and he was relieved to see the track improve this week to a Soft 7, allowing his stable star to have home advantage in his resuming run. "The track is looking like it is coming back a bit, so it gives some of those better track horses enough encouragement to put their hat in the ring, and it is a smart field," Greene said. "The firmer the better for him, and that is clearly shown in his form. All his work at home backs that up as well. I am hoping we might see that [track rating] move from a [Soft] 7 to a [Soft] 6, which would be a plus. We will definitely be running at those [track conditions] and just hoping for the best. He definitely won't start on a Heavy, 7 is the worse we would start him on."

Twain faces stern opening test

Twain (Per Incanto) faces a stern test in his opening assignment of the season, Saturday's Foxbridge Plate at Te Rapa, and trainer John Bell is hoping it will put him in good stead for some lofty sprinting targets. The six-year-old gelding performed with merit in last year's edition of the race, finishing fourth behind Sterling Express (Shamexpress) before going on to win the Sweynesse Stakes (Gr 3, 1215m) and finish runner-up in the Counties Bowl (Gr 3, 1100m). The son of Per Incanto (Street Cry) is set to follow a similar path this season, but this time geared towards an elite level target. "We will follow that same path, but the main aim will be the Railway," Bell said. "He is a year older and a bit smarter, but it will take a little bit more to get ready. I would like to think he will be somewhere in the first four or five."

HK: Fast Network prepares for Japan campaign

Fast Network (Wrote) is one of five horses expected to travel overseas and race on September 6, set to compete in Japan's Centaur Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) at Hanshin in preparation for the Sprinters Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) at Nakayama on September 27. Self Improvement (Deep Field), Romantic Thor (Justify) and Gorgeous Win (Press Statement), who also trialled on Friday, will race in Seoul, South Korea on the same day. Dennis Yip, trainer of Fast Network, said: "He trialled very good. He had a very good reaction, and because the track [condition] isn't very good, I just told the jockey to take him back and let him finish off in the straight. Everything is

fine." Settled at the tail of the group in the first trial, Fast Network was firmly restrained by jockey Matthew Poon before closing smartly in the home straight to finish fourth in 1m 12.44s.

Five for Maclean's Music

Wesley Ward's Bacio (3 c Katie's Kiss by Kantharos) produced an explosive front-running performance to land Friday's Nunthorpe Stakes (Gr 1, 5f) and become the fifth individual elite-level winner for Hill 'N Dale Farms stallion Maclean's Music (Distorted Humor). Having created a big impression when making all the running to land the Palace Of Holyroodhouse (5f) handicap at Royal Ascot in June, the three-year-old colt made the immediate jump up to Group 1 level as he never once looked like being reeled in to score by a length and a quarter. Starlust (Zoustar), who only returned to training this season after having stood one season at Riverstone Lodge in New South Wales in 2025, ran second with a nose further back to Rumstar (Havana Grey) in third place. Henry Dwyer's star mare Asfoora (Flying Artie), who landed the 2025 renewal of the Nunthorpe, ran a solid race to finish eighth, beaten less than four lengths by the winner in what was her final race. "That was some performance, all the credit goes to Bacio; I'm just happy to be here, enjoying the moment," winning rider Juan Hernandez said. "He was the one that fired, even before the gate he was trying to get ahead of the other guys, he kind of hit the gate a little bit but after that he was calm and he was ready. When the gate opened, he was all fire, he was trying to go too early, but I was able to take him back a little bit and save him for the last part." Bred by Torie Gladwell, Cincinnati Equine, and Borrowd, Bacio is raced by Myracehorse, Gladwell, Dailey, and Dejablu after having failed to sell

HK: Ka Ying Rising dazzles in trial ahead of return

It was business as usual at Sha Tin on Friday morning as Ka Ying Rising (Shamexpress) dominated his return barrier trial ahead of the 2026/27 season, when he'll reappear in the newly upgraded Chief Executive's Cup Handicap (Gr 3, 1200m).

Slated for a first-up run in the season opening feature on Sunday, September 6, which he won in 2024 and 2025 as a Class 1 contest, Ka Ying Rising lengthened sharply under Zac Purton by nine and three-quarter lengths in front of Thunder Prince (I Am Invincible) in 1m 01.16s over 1050 metres on the rain affected dirt as he led the field of seven from start to finish.

"He put on a bit of weight in the break. He got up over 1,190 pounds, so he's certainly enjoying his life. He'll only get one run on opening day here, and then he goes to The Everest," Purton said.

"He was a little bit rusty. He'll be fine. It's a starting point for him and it's nice to have him back there doing something a bit more competitive. He certainly needed that."

Meanwhile, trainer David Hayes confirmed that The Everest (Gr 1, 1200m) was the only race that appealed when discussing travel for Ka Ying Rising, a race in which he bids to go back-to-back in.

"Even at that first meeting I thought it was a bit of a gimmick race but, gee, the momentum it has gained in the last four years is quite amazing," Hayes told Racing NSW.

"It's not a gimmick race. Full credit to Peter V'landys, Racing NSW and the Australian Turf Club for putting on such a good show.

"I'd probably only like to travel this horse once a year and that's the only place I want to go. That speaks volumes for what I think of the race and what I think most people do."

UK: Arapaho Gold maintains unbeaten record in Gimcrack

The Michael Dods-trained Arapaho Gold (2 g Bayside Boy - Call Of The Jungle by Bungle Inthetjungle) stretched his unbeaten run to four on Friday when landing a big success in the Gimcrack Stakes (Gr 2, 6f) at York. Ridden by Connor Beasley, the gelding son of Bayside Boy (New Bay) found plenty under pressure to deny Final Objective (Sioux Nation) by three-quarters of a length. There was a further two and a quarter lengths back to Hell Of A Spin (Naval Crown) in third place. Having won two novice contests, Arapaho Gold then scored at Listed level in the Rose Bowl Stakes (Listed, 6f) prior to Friday's Group 2 victory.

UK: Al Nayyir makes it third time lucky in Lonsdale Cup

Having run a desperately narrow second in 2024 and third in 2025, the Tom Clover-trained Al Nayyir (8 g Dubawi - Bright Beacon by Manduro) made it third time lucky in Friday's Lonsdale Cup Stakes (Gr 2, 2m 0.5f) at York. The eight-year-old gelding was ridden for the first time in his career by William Buick and, having looked outpaced entering the final three furlongs, rallied gamely to lead inside the last furlong and beat Illinois (Galileo) by a length.

There was a further two and a quarter lengths back to Mount Atlas (Masar) in third place. The Lonsdale Cup Stakes was previously won in 2024 by Vauban (Galiway), who has since won back-to-back renewals of the Sky High Stakes (Gr 3, 2000m) and twice placed in Group 1 company for Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott.

UK: Maher buys Amazing Journey, Golden Eagle the target

Ciaron Maher has made another high-profile European acquisition after securing progressive three-year-old Amazing Journey (Starspangledbanner). The son of Starspangledbanner (Choisir) has been trained by Jamie Osbourne to five wins and a further two placings from just 11 starts and, following the gelding's success in the Moet & Chandon International Handicap (7f) at Ascot on July 25, a private deal was completed by Maher and his team. Amanzing Journey is set to be aimed at November's \$10 million Golden Eagle (Gr 1, 1500m), where he could come up against star mare Sheza Alibi (Saxon Warrior). "He's a super-progressive horse with a great turn of foot," Maher's bloodstock manager Will Bourne told the Racing Post. "He's the type of horse where you just don't know what his ceiling is or when he'll stop improving. That's the exciting thing about buying a horse like him. He's clearly going the right way and hopefully there's still plenty more to come from him. I think he can get a mile in Australia. He travels strongly through his races and has that turn of foot, which is something we really like to see in horses coming down here. We don't usually buy horses knowing we're running for second,

but when there's AU\$2 million for second, we're happy to aim him at the Golden Eagle and take on Sheza Alibi."

She is a sister to Group 3 winner and Epsom Derby (Gr 1, 1m 4f) and Hill Stakes (Gr 2, 1900m) runner-up Hoo Ya Mal, while also being a half-sister to five other winners including Greatest Journey (Raven's Pass) and Robert Johnson (Helmet) being out of the winning Montjeu (Sadler's Wells) mare Sensationally. 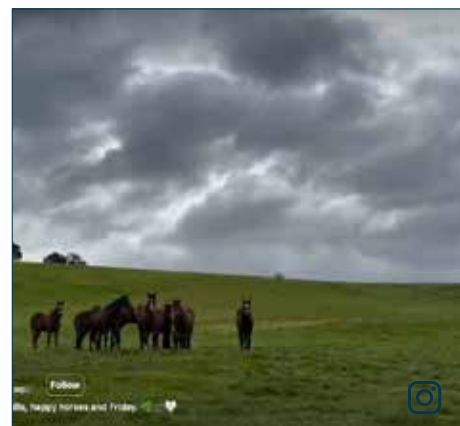

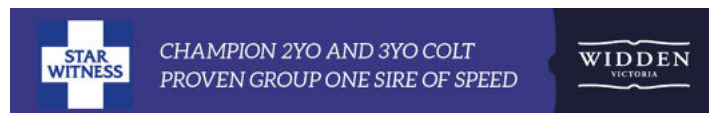
