LITTLE AVONDALE

Sired by magic

On an enchanting weekend of early spring racing, the sun shone, the good horses returned and the signs were strong that the Italian stallion whose name means "by magic" will be in for another powerhouse season.

Per Incanto (Street Cry), flagbearer for New Zealand's Little Avondale Stud, raised his latest stakes winner when Matt Smith's Prima Bella sealed a winning hat-trick in the Toy Show Quality (Gr 3, 1100m).

Remarkably, she became the fifth stakes winner by Per Incanto from the same family, and she gave her sire his 38th black type victor

from 731 runners worldwide at a more than healthy 5.20 per cent.

In Australia he now has 16 from 221 at a robust 7.24 per cent, underlining why he's increasingly popular west of the Tasman.

Per Incanto had a booming season in 2025-26, finishing sixth on the Australian general sires' table, up from a previous best of 15th the year before. And he did it with just 94 starters, while the rest of the top 10 averaged 280 apiece.

Back home, the sire of nine Group 1 winners took out New Zealand's two main stallion laurels, the Dewar Award for the highest Australasian progeny earnings and, for the second time, the Centaine Award for worldwide money.

Inglis unveils 321-lot Ready2Race catalogue

Inglis has released the catalogue for its 2026 Ready2Race Sale, with 321 two-year-olds catalogued for an auction that has continued to build its record as a source of high-class racehorses in Australasia. The Ready2Race Sale currently boasts the highest winners-to-runners ratio of any sale of its kind in the Southern Hemisphere, with last year's graduates already including Group 1-winning juvenile Tron Bolt (Toronado), dual stakes winner Hard Kick (All Too Hard) and Woodlands Stakes (Listed, 1100m) winner Queen Regent (Wild Ruler). Hard Kick has won two of his first three starts, taking the Talindert Stakes (Listed, 1100m) at two before returning this season to win the Vain Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m).

Continued from page 2 But there are strong signs the 22-year-old could match or better even those results in 2026-27, according to Little Avondale's Sam Williams.

Prima Bella, who continues a love affair with Per Incanto for Mystery Downs owners Frank and Christine Cook, has risen from benchmark 78 grade to winning a G3 through six runs in her winter campaign.

She remains lightly raced with just 15 starts to her name, having made her debut at three and then requiring a year off through injury immediately afterwards, so connections can likely look forward to more success with her this season. That includes continuing on this spring, trainer Smith said.

Two hours after her win, another star of Per Incanto's 2025-26 season, Gringotts, turned in a superb resumption when flashing home for third behind match race pair Autumn Glow (The Autumn Sun) and Sheza Alibi (Saxon Warrior) in a high quality Winx Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) deserving of its standing as the season's first top tier contest.

And in the second one this Saturday, Caulfield's Memsie Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m), Per Incanto's highest earner of last term Jimmysstar will kick his spring off. He is currently the \$3.50 favourite.

He might meet another Per Incanto there in the Cooks' triple Group winner Evaporate, the Team Hayes trained five-year-old who resumed with a third in Caulfield's Lawrence Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) last Saturday week.

The Hayes's six-year-old gelding Oak Hill, a G2 winner in February, is also set to resume soon.

Ciaran Maher's group one winning seven-year-olds Gringotts and Jimmysstar give proof of the ability of Per Incanto's stock to train on, but Williams is hugely excited by the stallion's younger brigades coming through.

His current three-year-olds are from his first crop sired when his service fee rose from \$NZ15,000 (plus GST) to \$25,000. And his new two-year-olds were conceived when his

fee doubled to \$50,000, bringing an increased quality of mares again.

Per Incanto, who's gone from \$60,000 to \$75,000 this year, and his son and sole barnmate Little Brose (\$15,000) have attracted the highest number of Australian mares Little Avondale has had for the coming spring. Breeders including Jonathan Munz, Sledmere Stud, North and Milburn Creek are among patrons.

Little wonder that despite Per Incanto's advancing years, Williams is in a bullish mood as the new season opens for the stallion, who was US-bred but raced in Italy.

"I'm pretty excited about the season ahead," Williams told ANZ Bloodstock News. "I think Per Incanto could be in for a very big year.

"The great thing about him is his horses train on; they're not just one season wonders.

"Gringotts turned in a very big run on Saturday. We'll see Jimmysstar in the Memsie, and Evaporate looks in for a very exciting campaign.

Continued from page 3 “So there’s some really nice older horses there who’ve got big campaigns ahead of them, but there’s also a lot of young Per Incantos coming through who trainers have big wraps on.

“He had four black type performing two-year-olds last season, from his first crop after his fee went to \$25,000 from \$15,000.

“They’re from his best book of mares to have hit the racetrack, and they’ve just turned three. And then his current two-year-olds came off a fee of \$50,000, so these are his better books coming through.”

year-olds to watch this spring, Williams highlighted Fortunato, co-trained by Jimmysstar's original conditioner Guy Lowry. The gelded full-brother to G1 winner Bonham debuted with a win at Taupo on August 16 and will surely come under attention from Australian buyers.

Roger James and Robert Wellwood have the gelding Incandescent, who won twice at two including in Listed class in June, while Tony Pike has Just The Berries, who debuted with a third at Te Aroha, also in June.

“Fortunato looks a very exciting horse,” Williams said. “Guy Lowry said to me, ‘Sam, I honestly think this horse could be up there with Jimmysstar,’ so that’s a big statement.

“Roger James and Robert Wellwood have a couple of really nice ones - Incandescent is showing great promise - and Tony Pike tells me Just The Berries is one of the better three-year-olds in his stable.”

While Per Incanto's new two-year-olds are from what Williams calls some of the finest

mares the stallion has attracted, the future also looks bright through the yearlings he'll have at market next year.

Little Avondale will offer a full brother to Evaporate who Williams describes as “a magnificent horse”.

There's also a filly “who's a stunner” and is a half-sister to last season's Goodwood (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Desert Lightning (Pride Of Dubai) and is a full-sister to Oak Hill and Oak Lightning, a gelding who was juvenile stakes placed at Caulfield on debut for Moody-Coleman in April before meeting a premature end.

“I wouldn't just say I've got the best draft on paper, but it's also the best draft on type that we've had going to the sales, led by a good number of Per Incanto's colts,” Williams said.

Prima Bella continues a stunning run of stakes winners for Per Incanto with the family of her Kiwi third dam Sound Lover (Sound Reason).

Evaporate, who's been four times G1-placed, also has Sound Lover as his third dam. She's the second dam of G3 winner Belluci Babe and Listed victor Pure Incanto, and she's the dam of the 2012-born gelding who kicked the pedigree cross off, Magnum, who won a New Zealand Listed before being multiple stakes-placed in Singapore.

Smith told ANZ Prima Bella would likely now stay in work to seek to also become a multiple stakes winner.

"She's come through the run really well," he said. "We're really happy with getting that

Group win on the board, which was obviously a big thing for a mare, and we'll keep going, I think.

"I haven't quite decided on a target - we could try her up at 1200 metres for the first time, or stick to 1000 or 1100, but there's a few options for her in Sydney and Melbourne.

"We thought she would get somewhere near this level previously but she didn't get there, but this prep she's just kept improving with every run."

Per Incanto, meanwhile, will be capped at 80 mares in his 16th covering season, while his Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winning six-year-old son Little Brose looks set to cover some 130 mares in his second, after serving 141 last year.

"We've limited Per Incanto's numbers, only because he's 22. I'm not worried about his fertility, we're just looking after him," Williams said. "And it becomes a matter of supply and demand now too.

"It's also exciting for Per Incanto that

we've got Little Brose standing beside him. That's where we can really capitalise. We've got people going to Little Brose who might not have the budget for Per Incanto.

"We've got the first couple of foals by Little Brose on the ground, and I couldn't be happier with them."

He added: "With the mares that are coming through the gate for Per Incanto, you can just see with the rise in his fee the difference in the page and certainly in the style and type of mare.

"He deserved to go to \$75,000, but once again in the proven stallion ranks, if you compare him to the top 10 in Australia and their service fees, he is outstanding value. He really is.

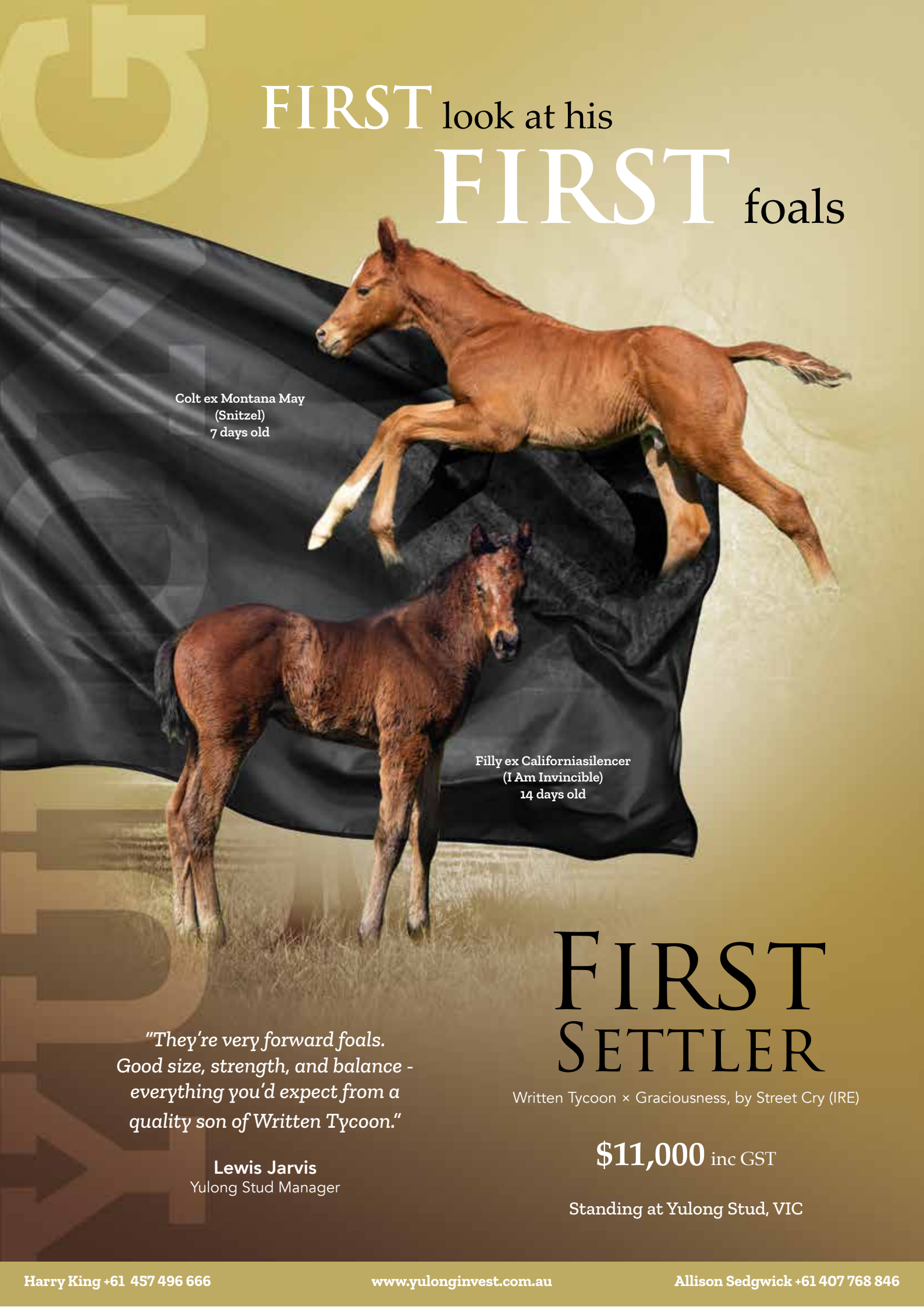
"He looks magnificent at the moment, as he's dropping his winter coat.

"It would be outstanding if he can be top 10 in Australia again this season, but I'd just love to see him picking up a good number of stakes horses and having another successful season on the track."

Just Party breaks drought in Goulburn Cup

Well bred Justify (Scat Daddy) five-year-old, Just Party returned to the winner's circle with victory in Sunday's Goulburn Cup (1400m), recording only the second win of his 21-start career and his first since March 2024. Despite his modest strike-rate, Just Party has been Group placed twice and delivered another Goulburn Cup success for the Ryan-Alexiou stable, which has now won three of the past six editions of the race. The last foal out of ARC New Zealand S., (Gr.1, 2000m) The Party Stand (Thorn Park), Just Party has now won over \$630k in prizemoney)

Hello Youmzain 3yo set for Up And Coming Stakes

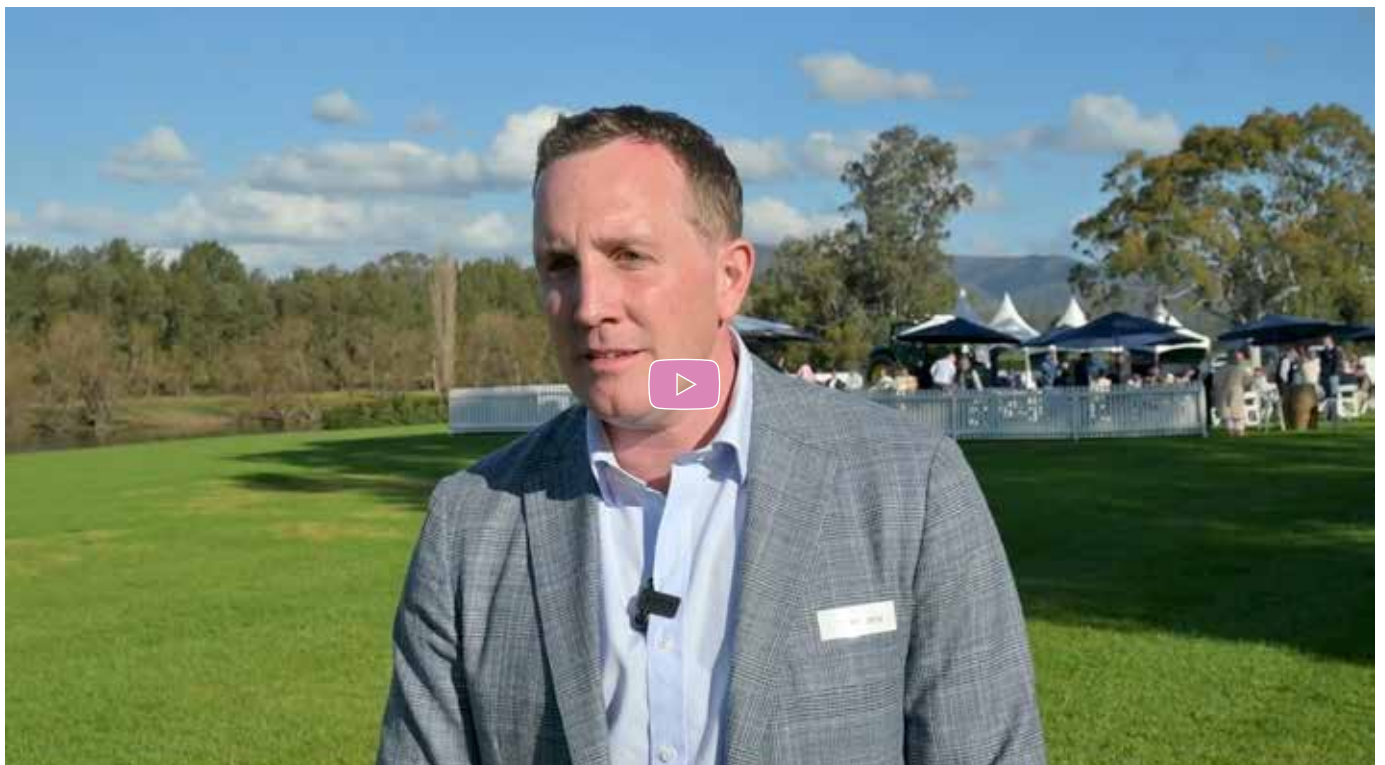
Baillieu Handicap (Gr 3, 1400m) runner-up Persian Wonder (Hello Youmzain) is set to step back into black-type company in Saturday's Up And Coming Stakes (Gr 3, 1300m) at Rosehill. By Cambridge Stud's Hello Youmzain (Kodiac), Persian Wonder finished fourth behind Warwoven (Sword of State) in the Pago Pago Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) before running second to Southend (Palace Pier) in the Baillieu and was subsequently spelled after contesting the Champagne Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m). He returned with a maiden victory at Canterbury in July before a solid effort against older horses under equal topweight last start. Out of Pivotal (Polar Falcon) sprinting mare

Steer The Stars, trainer David Payne believes 1400 metres will ultimately prove Persian Wonder's preferred distance, with the Ming Dynasty Quality (Gr 3, 1400m) a fortnight after the Up And Coming Stakes his principal early-spring target.

Too Darn Hot filly for Princess Series

Bangkok Hottie (Too Darn Hot) will continue through the Princess Series after an eye-catching second to Pembrey (Prague) in Saturday's Silver Shadow Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) at Randwick. A homebred for Kiwi born John Thompson, Bangkok Hottie is the first runner out of stakes placed Medaglia d'Oro mare Bangkok.

Reminder BOBS 2026 nominations close September 1

Nominations for the 2026 BOBS Racehorse Owners Bonus Scheme, including BOBS Extra are open for horses foaled in 2024 with the nomination period applies to horses that turned two on August 1, 2026, with standard nominations closing on Tuesday, September 1. Late nominations will continue to be accepted between September 1, 2026 and August 1, 2027, but will attract a fee of \$5,500 including GST.

Station One named CRV Horse of the Year Toronado (High Chaparral) gelding Station One was crowned the 2025/26 Country Racing Victoria Horse of the Year at the annual CRV Awards in Melbourne on Saturday night. Etah James leaves her mark with Makarov

Makarov (Russian Camelot) made an impressive start to his career at Hastings on Saturday, providing another chapter for the family of Sydney Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) winner Etah James (Raise The Flag). The four-year-old debutant, trained by Bill Thurlow, had been given plenty of time to mature and arrived at his 1400-metre debut following a pair of encouraging 1000-metre trial placings before producing a convincing victory. "He was pretty impressive," co-breeder Mark Lupton said. "We have waited a while for it, but we always thought it was coming." Makarov is the first foal out of Etah James, who won seven races headed by the Sydney Cup, Lord Reims Stakes (Gr 3, 2600m) and Pakenham Cup (Listed, 2500m), while she was also runner-up in the Avondale Cup (Gr 2, 2400m) and contested the 2020 Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m). Lupton believes Makarov has inherited his dam's staying potential, while showing more natural speed at

The broader graduate list includes Group 1 winner Libertad (Russian Revolution), millionaires Democracy Manifest (Flying Artie), Tavi Time (Tavistock) and Strait Acer (Headwater), and dual Group 1 winner Nettoyer (Sebring), alongside stakes performers including Cristal Clear (Exceedence), Forgot You (Savabeel), Lightsaber (Zoustar), Allibor (All Too Hard), Malkovich (Choisir), Title Fighter (Lean Mean Machine), Bev's Nine (Shalaa), Trumbull (Darci Brahma), Gunstock (Tavistock) Prix De Turn (Turn Me Loose) and Buggsy (Harry Angel). The sale has also produced significant results internationally.

Hong Kong Classic Cup winner and Group 1-placed Rubylot (Rubick) heads a list of Hong Kong graduates that includes Crimson Flash (Showtime), Handsome Bo Bo (Helmet), Wishful Thinker (I Am Invincible), Super Wealthy (Epaulette) and Sugar Sugar (Star Turn) while Perak Derby winner Guru Fight (Guru Fight) is among its successful Malaysian graduates.

Of the 321 lots catalogued for this year's sale, 232 were purchased at auction specifically for the Ready2Race Sale, complemented by a significant number of homebreds.

The catalogue features progeny by established sires including I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit), Zoustar (Northern Meteor),

Frankel (Galileo), Gun Runner (Candy Ride), Siyouni (Pivotal), Toronado (High Chaparral), Too Darn Hot (Dubawi), Home Affairs (I Am Invincible), Ole Kirk (Written Tycoon), Savabeel (Zabeel), Harry Angel (Dark Angel), So You Think (High Chaparral), Super Seth (Dundeel), Wootton Bassett (Iffraaj), Starspangledbanner (Choisir), Dundeel (High Chaparral), Exceed And Excel (Danehill), The Autumn Sun (Redoute's Choice), Street Boss (Street Cry), Written Tycoon (Iglesia) and Ghaiyyath (Dubawi). First-crop sires represented include Anamoe (Street Boss), Artorius (Flying Artie), In The Congo (Snitzel) and Diatonic (Lord Kanaloa).

Pedigree strength is also prominent, with 111 lots out of black-type performers or producers. Breeze-up sessions will be held at Warwick Farm on September 25, Taupo on September 28 and Wangaratta on September 29, with footage to be uploaded to the Inglis website and app within 48 hours of each session.

"This sale has real momentum and the catalogue is fantastic," Inglis Bloodstock chief executive Sebastian Hutch said. "We have been working with vendors for years to build the profile of this sale and the performance of graduates, over the past 12 months in particular, has been hugely encouraging. Inglis Bloodstock CEO Sebastian Hutch is excited for the sale.

"The Inglis Ready2Race Sale is definitively the best 2YO sale in Australia but the objective is for it to become the best 2YO sale in Australasia and this catalogue is a huge step towards that. We are fortunate to have the best consignors supporting this sale again this year, people who are experts in the education and development of young racehorses and that is reflected in the success of graduates in recent years and in the quality of the horses that people will see on the breeze up days and at the sale itself."

Etah James is currently based at Coolmore Stud in Australia and is due to foal to St Mark's Basilica (Siyouni). She also has a three-year-old by Saxon Warrior (Deep Impact) and a yearling filly by Churchill (Galileo). Makarov was bred by Mark and Cath Lupton in partnership with Terry Reid and Gary Howes, the same group who bred and raced Etah James. Connections are expected to continue taking a patient approach with Makarov, with another lower-grade assignment likely before he is asked to tackle stronger company.

Hawke's Bay Guineas target for Fortunato

Promising Per Incanto (Street Cry) three-year-old Fortunato has come through his debut victory at Taupo in good order and is likely to be aimed at the Hawke's Bay Guineas (Gr 2, 1400m) at Hastings next month. Trainer Guy Lowry has given Fortunato some time in the paddock following his first-up success before beginning preparations for a potential appearance during the stable's home carnival. "He has got a bit of talent, so I look forward to him getting ready for something like the Hawke's Bay Guineas," Lowry said. Out of Redoute's Choice (Danehill) mare Fortune's Choice, Fortuna is a full brother to WRC Levin Classic (Gr.1 1600m) winner Bonham.

Great New Zealand Jumps Carnival returns to Te Aroha

The Great New Zealand Jumps Carnival will return to Te Aroha for its second edition on September 18 and 20, bringing together two of New Zealand's most historic jumping features. Launched in 2025, the two-day carnival became the permanent home of the former Great Northern Hurdle and Great Northern Steeplechase, which were renamed the Great New Zealand Hurdle and Great New Zealand Steeplechase. Last year's inaugural Great New Zealand Hurdle was won by Taika (Mettre De Jeu) for trainers Paul Nelson and Corrina McDougal under Mathew Gillies, while Jesko (Atlante) claimed the Great New Zealand Steeplechase for Shaun and Hazel Fannin. "We

were very proud of what was achieved in the first year," Racing Te Aroha president Raewyn Armstrong said. "There was a real sense of occasion across the weekend and, importantly, a wonderful feeling of camaraderie amongst the jumps racing community." This year's carnival will also feature retired thoroughbreds from AnnaRehab, whose Equine Assisted Learning program provides former racehorses with second careers. A Saturday evening function hosted by racecaller George Simon will return at Te Aroha Racecourse, including a charity auction raising funds for the New Zealand Horse Ambulance Trust. The inaugural function raised more than NZ\$5,000 for the Trust last year.



Asia

10 for Mikki Isle

Former Arrowfield shuttler Mikki Isle (Deep Impact) sired his tenth Stakes winner when Sound Moryana recorded her first graded stakes victory when landing Sunday's Keeneland Cup (Gr 3, 1200m) at Sapporo. Four-year-old Sound Moryana broke sharply and settled prominently in second before responding strongly to take control before comfortably holding off the late challenge of last years winner and subsequent Golden Eagle (Gr 1, 1500m) runner Panja Tower (Tower of London). The Keeneland Cup success represented a career-best performance for Sound Moryana and could open the door to higher-level sprint targets later in the season.

Lloyd and Lane, second and third in WAS Jockeys

Australian jockey Zac Lloyd finished runner-up in Japan's World All-Star Jockeys at Sapporo, ending the four-race series five points behind winner Norihiro Yokoyama. Lloyd, who led the standings after the opening day with 40 points, finished the two-day competition with 58 points despite not winning a leg. "Absolutely fantastic. I didn't ride a winner, so I don't deserve to win, and the jockey next to me rode fantastically," Lloyd said. "He rode two winners out of four races, so he's a deserved winner." Yokoyama accumulated 63 points after winning two of the four legs, becoming the first jockey to win the JRA international jockeys' series three times.

The 58-year-old had previously won in 1995 and 2009 when the competition was known as the World Super Jockeys Series. Fellow Australian Damian Lane finished third on 56 points. After ending the opening day fourth on 24 points, Lane added 32 points on Sunday with a fourth placing in the third leg and a close second in the final race.

Defiantly books Melbourne Cup berth in Kergorlay

Australian Bloodstock's Defiantly (Kameko) secured his place in the Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) with a dominant victory in the Prix Kergorlay (Gr 2, 3000m) at Deauville. The Joseph O'Brien-trained four-year-old was sent straight to the front of the five horse field and controlled the staying contest throughout to defeat Santorini Star (Golden Horn) by five-and-a-half lengths. Dual Kergorlay winner Double Major (Daiwa Major) was another five lengths away in third. Defiantly had already advertised his staying potential with victory in a valuable handicap at Goodwood and Sunday's success guaranteed him a berth in the Melbourne Cup. Bred by Qatar Bloodstock, Defiantly is out of the Galileo (Saddler's Wells) mare Roheryn and is a sibling to Underwood Stakes (Gr 1, 1800m) winner Buckaroo (Fastnet Rock) and Middle Earth (Roaring Lion), who finished third in last year's Melbourne Cup.

94 for Wootton Bassett

Woot Woot (Wootton Bassett) earned a first Group victory with an all-the-way success in Sunday's Prix du Calvados (Gr 2, 1400m) at Deauville. The Christopher Head trained two-year-old, who races for LNJ Foxwoods, had finished third in the Prix Six Perfections (Gr 3, 1400m) at the same course three weeks earlier. Woot Woot went

straight to the front and controlled the six-runner contest throughout before proving too strong for her rivals. Head believes Woot Woot will ultimately be best suited over a mile, with the Prix Marcel Boussac (Gr 1, 1600m) among her options, while a trip to the United States for the Breeders' Cup is also under consideration. Woot Woot was purchased for €250,000 at the 2025 Arqana August Yearling Sale and has now won two of her four starts. Woot Woot is the first black-type performer produced by stakes-winning G3 Prix Cleopatre third Penny Lane (Lord Of England), herself a full-sister to G1 Preis der Diana heroine Palmas.

New Bay geldings firm for Melbourne Cup

A son of Dubawi (Dubai Millenium), New Bay quinnellaed the Ebor Handicap (2787m) on Saturday at York, with trainer George Boughey declaring the Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) an ideal target for narrowly defeated Hopewell Rock. The Wathnan Racing-owned gelding arrived at York off a valuable handicap victory at Glorious

Goodwood and looked set to complete the double when challenging Daiquiri Bay (New Bay) late, only for that gelding to fight back along the rail and prevail by a head. "The Melbourne Cup has been the plan for a while; he's a very straightforward and honest horse who clearly stays the trip well," Boughey said. "He loves a big field, so I think he's absolutely tailor-made for it." Hopewell Rock's Ebor placing satisfies an important Melbourne Cup ballot clause, although his current rating of 106 may need to rise further to secure a place in the final field of 24. Wathnan Racing adviser Richard Brown also indicated the Qatari-based operation is keen to pursue a first Australian runner. Ebor winner Daiquiri Bay is unlikely to make the trip despite earning a potential pathway towards Melbourne, with trainer Alan King dismissing an Australian campaign after the race.

Forever Young set for Jockey Club Gold Cup return

Defending Breeders' Cup Classic (Gr 1) winner Forever Young (Real Steel) will

return to the United States for the Jockey Club Gold Cup (Gr 1) on September 18 before attempting to retain his Breeders' Cup crown at Keeneland on October 31. Trainer Yoshito Yahagi confirmed the campaign after finalising plans with owner Susumu Fujita, with the Jockey Club Gold Cup to serve as Forever Young's sole lead-up to the Breeders' Cup Classic. Yahagi said managing the six-week gap between the two races had been an important consideration after the five-year-old was unable to reproduce his best in Dubai following successive victories in Saudi Arabia. Forever Young is expected to remain at Belmont following his first-up assignment, where he will train alongside stablemate Shin Emperor (Siyouni), before travelling by charter flight to Cincinnati on October 20 and completing his final preparations at Keeneland. Forever Young, bred by Northern Farm, won last year's Breeders' Cup Classic after earlier international victories including the Saudi Cup (Gr 1).
