## Tait's twin roles make him a major player

As the owner of Twin Hills Stud and manager of Wathnan Racing, Olly 'Two Hats' Tait has become very adept at juggling roles and after a weekend which saw both organisations make their mark on opposite sides of the world, the highly respected breeder could play a central role in the upcoming spring carnival.

Having checked out the competition at the Hunter Valley stallion parades last Saturday morning, Tait settled in to watch Buccleuch (Peltzer) carry the family's famous colours to a resounding win at Sandown that afternoon before burning the midnight oil to watch York's time-honoured Ebor Handicap (1m 6f), in which a pair of Wathnan runners filled the minor placings in a blanket finish.

### Morning Briefing

#### Waller to send out five in Memsie

Champion trainer Chris Waller could potentially have a team of five headed to Saturday's Memsie Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Caulfield, with the quintet all made up of males.

Waller landed the Winx Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) last weekend with top mare Autumn Glow (The Autumn Sun) and could have Angel Capital (Harry Angel), Birdman (Free Eagle), Beiwacht (Bivouac), Buckaroo (Fastnet Rock) and Autumn Boy (The Autumn Sun) in the second Group 1 race of the season.

"It's only bad luck that is holding him back from being a multiple Group 1 winner," Waller said of Angel Capital.

**Continued from page 2** Had Hopewell Rock (New Bay) stuck his neck out just a touch further, the cheers from the living room might have woken the entire Tait clan from their collective slumbers. As it was, the family patriarch was left with a nagging feeling of what might have been after the northern hemisphere four-year-old was narrowly denied a golden ticket to the Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) by another son of New Bay (Dubawi) in Daiquiri Bay, who like Wathnan's other placegetter Opportunity (Frankel) won't be making the trip to Australia.

By way of compensation, Hopewell Rock's runner-up finish at least saw him successfully pass the ballot clause for the Melbourne Cup - so now the \$10 million question is whether George Boughey's emerging stayer will be assigned enough weight by the chief handicapper to guarantee a place on Australian racing's grandest stage.

All will be revealed when the weight scale comes out in mid-September, after

which Hopewell Rock's connections - on the assumption that he has passed the necessary vet checks - will make a final decision over whether the gallant gelding makes the very short trip to Newmarket's pre-export quarantine facilities to commence his Australian adventure.

"It was hugely disappointing to be beaten a short half-head in the Ebor, it's a great race and we would've loved to have won it," Tait told ANZ News.

"So it was frustrating to have come so close, but for Hopewell Rock it's still a big stepping stone towards the Melbourne Cup. I'll leave the planning to George [Boughey] and his team, but at this stage it's very much the intention for the horse to come out to Melbourne. I believe the veterinary procedures will commence this week, so as long he clears all the scans then it's all systems go.

"It's such a balancing act between getting a weight that allows him to be competitive but still gets him into the race - although I'm sure after the weekend the dye has been cast and the

handicapper has made up his mind, so what will be will be. But we do think he's the right sort of horse for the Melbourne Cup, so hopefully he gets his chance."

Given that Wathnan's retained rider James Doyle is unlikely to make the weight allocated to Hopewell Rock, a general \$26 chance in Melbourne Cup markets, local son of a gun Zac Lloyd could be the beneficiary having successfully linked up with Boughey on several occasions during his recent riding stint in the United Kingdom.

But Doyle, who tasted elite-level success in Australia aboard subsequent Telemon stallion Jungle Cat (Iffraaj) in the Sir Rupert Clarke Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m), will have first refusal on Wathnan's Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) contender Map Of Stars (Sea The Stars).

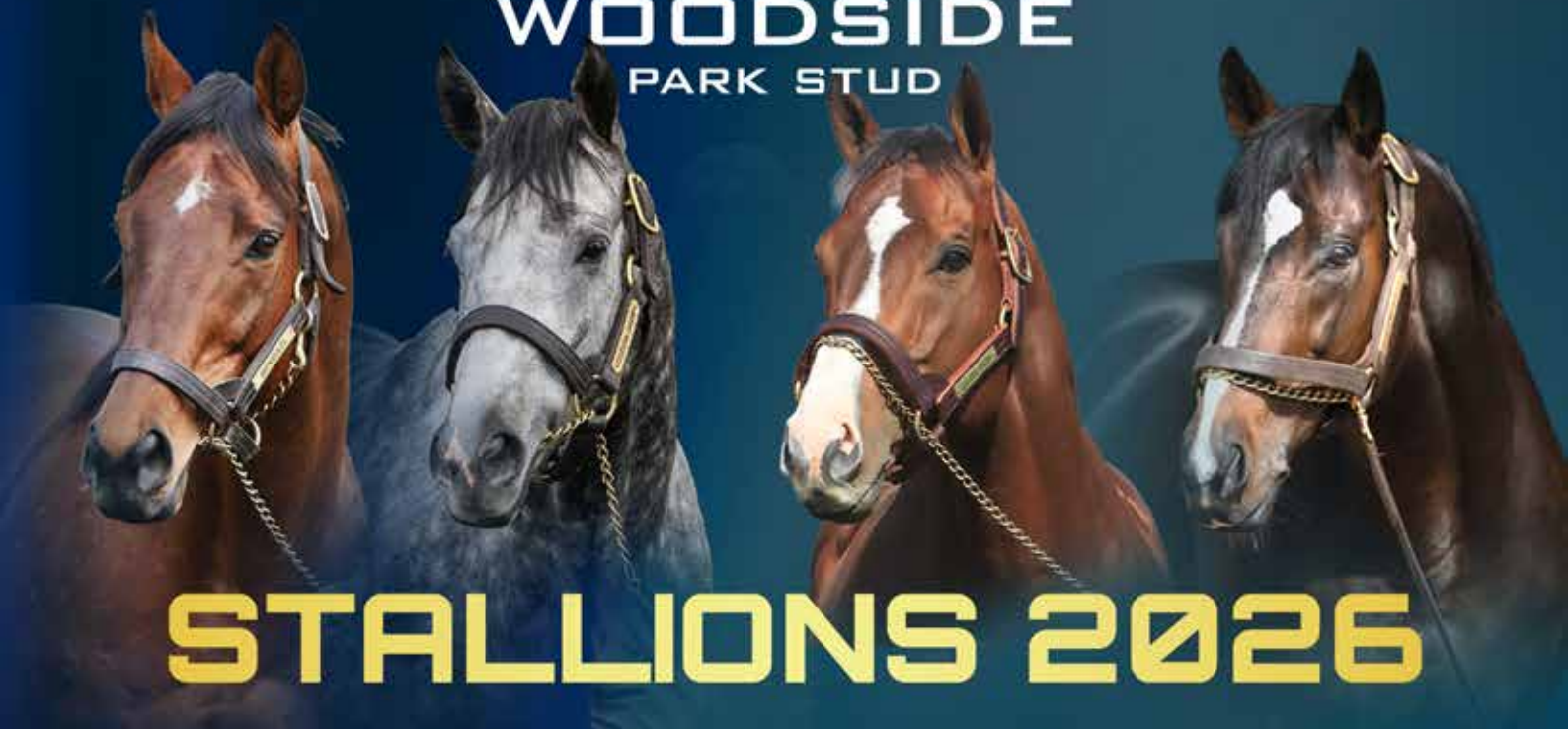

**Continued from page 3** trained galloper is provisionally booked to board the first shipment of international raiders which is due to touch down in Melbourne at the end of September.

"You couldn't call him progressive because he's been a good horse for a while now, but he's come back in excellent order this season after being gelded," Tait told ANZ News.

"His win at Royal Ascot was fabulous, and then he backed it up with a very good run the other day in the Group 3 race at Deauville. He's put some very consistent performances together this season and he's a magnificent looking horse, so we're excited to see him come over. You have to be a very good horse to win a Cox Plate so he'll have to bring his best form here, but we think it's well worth giving it a shot.

"He has a high rating in Europe so I'd be very confident he could compete against the best weight-for-age horses in Australia. If you look at the markets, he's rated around the \$15 mark so the bookmakers would agree. I also think

the fact that the Cox Plate is run at Flemington this year is an advantage for him, because he's probably more suited on bigger tracks."

Closer to home, Tait and his Twin Hills team have been busy welcoming around 20 fresh foals to the world, with many sired by their well-regarded stallion Daumier (Epaulette).

The buzz around Daumier's first crop, which have just turned two, is starting to grow louder and Tait is fervently hoping that anticipation can translate into some early results for the 2022 Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner, who will stand for an unchanged service fee of \$16,500 (inc GST) this season.

"If you're in this industry, it doesn't get any more exciting than to stand a stallion whose first crop is about to hit the racetrack," he told ANZ News.

"Our dream is that he's going to become a great stallion, so hopefully his two-year-olds can perform well. He's produced lovely foals all the way through, they've sold well so far, they look the same as him and importantly they've

got great temperaments. It's still early days but the feedback we have received so far is very positive, so it would be nice to think he could have some early success. It's an incredible opportunity for any stud farm to stand a Blue Diamond winner, and we take that opportunity seriously.

"He was a very good two-year-old, so you'd hope that his progeny are as precocious as he was and the early signs are good. Anthony Freedman always said that one of Daumier's main strengths was his noteworthy demeanour, which he seems to have passed onto his progeny. At this stage his oldest horses have only been broken in, so all you can really judge them on is their temperament and whether or not they move well. He's ticked both of those boxes so far, so fingers crossed they have the ability to match."

With a pair of stakes winners from his very first crop in Thanks Gorgeous and the aforementioned Buccleuch, Daumier's fellow resident Peltzer (So You Think) has made solid

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**Continued from page 5** strides since joining Twin Hills' foundation stallion Smart Missile (Fastnet Rock) on the farm's boutique roster.

If the Patrick Payne-trained Buccleuch - bred by Tait's famous father Sandy - can continue to rise through the grades and potentially make his way into Group company this spring, it would undoubtedly help his old man attract some better mares.

"He's always been a good horse and it was a huge thrill to see him come back like that, especially for Dad," Tait told ANZ News.

"He was an outstanding two-year-old, he easily beat Observer at his fourth start and won a stakes race at Flemington by more than three lengths at his fifth start, which is no mean feat. He didn't come up during his three-year-old season, but he had some throat issues so there were legitimate excuses. He had a long time off after his wind operation, but at the weekend he won like a good horse - which is what we think he is.

"It was only a Benchmark race, but the way he won it [by 4.5 lengths] would suggest there are bigger and better things in store for him this spring, so hopefully he can give Peltzer a timely

boost. For a stallion operating at his service fee [\$11,000], he's built a good record but another stakes win alongside his name would look very nice."

## Maher's Jimmysstar ready to go

Ciaran Maher is confident that his three-time Group 1 winner Jimmysstar (Per Incanto) can put in a bold effort this weekend when he contests the Memsie Stakes. The seven-year-old gelding was last seen running second in the Kingsford-Smith Cup (Gr 1, 1300m) in May and has not raced in Melbourne since finishing seventh in the William Reid Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) back in March. "He worked at Warwick Farm yesterday [Monday] on the course proper. His work was very sharp. His two jumpouts have been very sharp, this prep, and I'm just rapt with the way he's come up," Maher told Racing.com. "His couple of runs in the autumn, he might not have been at his best, but he seems to have come back really well, and he's in a good spot. I'm very much looking forward to him kicking off in the Memsie - 1400 metres is arguably his best trip, at the moment, and he's got a great record at Caulfield. He's full of running and zinging up in pretty slick times, and he hasn't been asked to do anything, either. I'm sure he'll make his presence felt."

## Waller to send out five in Memsie

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"It's only bad luck that is holding him back from being a multiple Group 1 winner," Waller said of Angel Capital. "He'll get his chance on Saturday, but I am a little bit concerned about the track.

"His better form is on better tracks, but the beauty of Caulfield is it does dry very well. The 1400 metres is a good distance for him, and he normally runs well at Caulfield. He's come on well and if anything, better than I

thought. He's held his weight as he's a mature colt now.

"Birdman, Jye McNeil was aboard, and he said he felt great, had a good attitude. He found good form down here in the autumn and he carried it right through to Brisbane, winning the Doomben Cup. He resumes ahead of a good preparation, we hope."

Meanwhile, Waller said Autumn Boy would remain in Melbourne following Saturday's Memsie after being scratched from the Winx, and that Beiwacht, who also missed the Winx due to an elevated temperature, had been given the all clear by vets for this weekend's contest.

"He's a stallion, a multiple Group 1 winner, and we're keen to get him to a Cox Plate," Waller said of Autumn Boy. "There's lots of options down here and once he gets out to 1600, 1800, 2000 metres, he will be a horse to be reckoned with.

"His [Beiwacht] blood profile was back to normal yesterday and the vets allowed us to gallop him this morning, and he galloped well. Providing he comes through the work well, we will accept with him on Wednesday."

## Guest House expected to keep on improving

Guest House's (Home Affairs) co-trainer Michael Kent Jnr is full of hope that the Golden Slipper (Gr 1, 200m)-winning colt can be an even better three-year-old as he gears up for his race return. Pierro (Lonhro) (2012) was the last Golden Slipper-winning colt to return and win another race in their career so history is against Guest House, but Kent Jnr feels the son of Home Affairs (I Am Invincible) is continuing to improve. "He is getting better and better, all the time," Kent Jnr, who trains in partnership with Mick Price, told The Verdict podcast on Tuesday. "I just wonder if he was more a three-year-old type that was good enough to win the Slipper? His sire was the same. Home Affairs was a handy two-year-old but a brilliant three-year-old. It wouldn't surprise if he got better at three. I think he'll improve." Guest House will make his return in Saturday's San Domenico Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) at Rosehill. "He hasn't missed a beat," Kent Jnr added.

## Music Time to kick off Golden Rose campaign

Black Opal Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) winner and Golden Slipper placegetter Music Time (All Too Hard) will make his return on Saturday when tackling the San Domenico Stakes at Rosehill. Trained by Canberra-based Gratz Vella, the three-year-old gelding is on a path towards the Golden Rose (Gr 1, 1400m) this campaign and Vella feels he is in good form ahead of this weekend after a trial hitout over 1040 metres on August 14. "I said to Tommy Berry before his trial 'he hasn't had too much, a couple of nice gallops and one jump out, just go easy with him today and it's only going to benefit him,'" Vella said. "And he come back in and said 'Gratz, this horse is a lot more forward than what you think he is.' He's come on very well from his two-year-old season, especially since that barrier trial. He had a good gallop Tuesday morning with one of my senior horses and matched strides with him, the jockey came in and said how good he was. Who's to say he can't make it in a Golden Rose, because the horse's he's racing this weekend were mainly in the Golden Slipper and he didn't finish too far away from the winner."

## San Domenico first-up for returning Revengeance

The Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott-trained Revengeance (Hellbent) will have his first-up outing in Saturday's San Domenico Stakes. The three-year-old Hellbent (I Am Invincible) colt has had three trials since early July and will look to improve on his third placing in the Breeders' Plate (Gr 3, 1000m) and win in the Golden Gift (1100m), having been out with a knee injury since that victory. "He looks in excellent shape, he's come back really well, he's matured and strengthened up nicely off his early two-year-old campaign," Bott said on Sky Sports Radio. "I liked his latest trial and he looks fantastic going into his first-up run. We've been able to give him the three trials, he's had a nice steady build up and I'm sure there's some nice improvement to come. I'd like to think he can measure up to these horses but I do think he will be better suited deeper into the campaign potentially getting out over a bit further as well."

## Oliveanotherday set for The Heath

Last-start Wangoom Handicap (Listed, 1100m) winner Oliveanotherday (Nicconi) will bid to make it five wins on the trot, and potentially book himself a spot in a Group 1, when he heads to Caulfield for The Heath (Gr 3, 1100m). Having worked his way up from handicap grade, the four-year-old Nicconi (Bianconi) gelding then secured a first stakes success in the Wangoom, beating Immortal Star (I Am Immortal) by two and a half lengths, and Tom Dabernig feels he can continue the step up in grades. "Three to four is always a funny transition, but as a three-year-old he was in races where he was beating older horses, so I think he's a horse that can make that transition fine," Dabernig said. "He trialled at Caulfield last Wednesday and

trialled really well and he pulled up well. He's had a nice build-up, he's had two trials and seems to be going well. He hasn't been to Flemington yet, so what we're considering is maybe the Bobbie Lewis [second-up] and trying it early, which might help map out what we do. The straight is an unknown and I didn't want to go first-up down the straight, so I thought we can get that run into him and then make that call on what we do."

## Melanite bidding for back-to-back wins

The John Thompson-trained Melanite (Dirty Work) will bid to make it back-to-back wins on Wednesday when he heads to Canterbury for the Ranvet Handicap (1100m). Melanite took advantage of a good run on the fence to score at Randwick in a Benchmark 72 (1100m) earlier this month and Thompson is hoping for a similar scenario this week from the plum barrier. "He's going well, his first two runs were good on heavy tracks," Thompson told Racing NSW. "On top of the ground third-up he won well. Kerrin [McEvoy] has been happy with him, he's been riding him between runs, he hasn't missed a beat. Barrier one helps, we were in on Saturday but we drew the outside gate and didn't run. He's always had ability, he hasn't had much luck in a couple of runs but he's been racing consistently this preparation. He's a sprinter, but what the perfect distance is I don't really know."

## Harry's Evidence to keep up good form

Another runner at Canterbury on Wednesday aiming to make it successive wins is the Gerald Ryan and Sterling Alexiou-trained Harry's Evidence (Harry Angel). The five-year-old gelding landed a Benchmark 64 (1100m) at Canterbury on August 5 and will return to that track on Wednesday to contest the Asahi Super Dry Handicap (1250m). "He's a bit of a quirky customer but he's always had plenty of talent," Alexiou told Racing NSW. "It's just been getting him to realise it and grow up a bit mentally. It's more mental than anything, he was a bit inclined to overdo things early in his career. He wanted to go too hard and over race. He's gone the other way and is relaxing really well, we're looking forward to getting out over 1400 metres this preparation."

## RQ appoints Henderson as race starter specialist

Matthew Henderson has been appointed to the role of race starter specialist at Racing Queensland (RQ). Henderson will play a vital role in shaping the future of racing in Queensland by building the capability of those working behind the barriers. The new role exists to establish and embed consistent starting procedures for clubs across the state, and to train and empower those responsible for the commencement of races. Henderson commences at RQ having previously worked as Ciaran Maher Racing's farm manager at Bong Bong. Prior to that, Matthew worked in a number of operations roles at both Archer Park and RQ, which included raceday management of starters and judges. "I'm delighted to have been appointed to this role with Racing Queensland and am really looking forward to making a difference in this crucially important area," Henderson said. "I'm under no illusion that there will be challenges faced along the journey, however the opportunity to work with clubs, participants and all stakeholders in a field I have a real passion for is exciting."

### HK: Romantic Warrior to undergo further assessment on joint change

The Hong Kong Jockey Club's department of veterinary clinical services has provided advice on Romantic Warrior (Acclamation) that the club wishes to share. Romantic Warrior has undergone detailed physical examinations, including the use of state-of-the-art imaging equipment at the club's veterinary hospital. This proactive screening has revealed a change in one of the horse's joints that requires further detailed assessment by the veterinary team. More information will be provided in due course.

### HK: Fast Network and others depart for assignments

The Dennis Yip-trained Fast Network (Wrote) left for Japan on Tuesday. The horse will contest the Centaur Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) at Hanshin on Sunday, September 6 and the Sprinters

### Bellatrix Star retired, to be offered on Inglis Digital

Group 1 performer Bellatrix Star (Star Witness) has been retired from racing following a second fibrillation episode and will be offered for sale as a broodmare prospect on Inglis Digital next month.

She was initially purchased by Te Akau Racing principal Sir David Ellis, on behalf of Fortuna Racing, out of Phoenix Park's 2023 New Zealand Bloodstock Book 1 Yearling Sale draft for \$80,000, and joined the Matamata barn of trainers Mark Walker and Sam Bergerson.

Having landed the Eclipse Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) as a juvenile, Bellatrix Star was then sent to Te Akau's Cranbourne barn. As a three-year-old in Australia she won the Cap D'Antibes Stakes (Listed, 1100m), Scarborough Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) and Schillaci Stakes (Gr 2, 1100m) and ran second to now Coolmore-based stallion Switzerland (Snitzel) in the Coolmore Stud Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) at Flemington on Derby Day.

Bellatrix Star would then have a series of unfortunate events, which began in January last year when she fractured vertebrae in her neck after rearing and falling over when heading back to her stable, and while she made a miracle recovery from that, she had to undergo surgery following her returning run in the Doveton Stakes (Listed, 1100m) at Caulfield last November.

"In January last year she had that very unfortunate fall where she flipped over backwards and broke a vertebrae in her neck," Fortuna's John Galvin said.

"At the time the vet said she would never race again but Mark Walker worked his magic, and we were able to rehabilitate

her. She went through a preparation with long paddock spells and a bit of dressage.

"When she resumed racing at Caulfield in late November, she just ran below par and the next morning we found that she had a chip in a fetlock. That was removed and it took some time after that for rehab and to get her back going again."

Bellatrix Star's troubles weren't over, with a veterinary examination prior to what was meant to be her resuming run at Caulfield in May finding her to be fibrillating, resulting in her subsequent scratching.

With no further signs of fibrillation, she was cleared to race and resumed with a pleasing runner-up effort in the Sir John Monash Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) at Caulfield last month. She was then freshened, and while preparing for next month's Moir Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m) she suffered a second heart fibrillation and the decision has now been made to retire her.

"Bellatrix Star has been a wonderful performer for her large ownership group," Galvin said. "She delivered winning performances in New Zealand as a two-year-old and performed brilliantly in Melbourne in the spring of her three-year-old season."

"Sadly, this fibrillation issue reared its head again and in the very best interests of the horse, she is to be retired and offered for sale as a broodmare prospect."

Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) at Nakayama on Sunday, September 27. Meanwhile, fellow Hong Kong gallopers Beauty Waves (Starspangledbanner), Gorgeous Win (Press Statement) and Self Improvement (Deep Field) departed from Sha Tin Racecourse for Seoul, South Korea, also on Tuesday. Beauty Waves, Gorgeous Win and Self Improvement will compete in the Korea Sprint (Gr 3, 1200m) at Seoul Racecourse on Sunday, September 6, while Romantic Thor (Justify), who became unsettled prior to loading at the

airport for his flight, has since been withdrawn from the Korea Cup (Gr 2, 1800m) and will not travel to South Korea.

## FR: Jean-Claude Rouget to retire next month

One of France's most successful trainers, Jean-Claude Rouget, has announced he will retire from training at the end of September. A dual winner of the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe (Gr 1, 2400m), Rouget revealed that his yards in Pau will enter into liquidation on September 25 unless a buyer for the business can be found. Now 73 years of age and having been diagnosed with cancer in 2024, Rouget had his first Group 1 winner in 1994 when Millkom (Cyrano De Bergerac) landed the Prix Jean Prat (Gr 1, 1800m) and has gone on to train champions such as Almanzor (Wootton Bassett), Brametot (Rajsaman), Vadeni (Churchill), and both his

Arc winners Sottsass (Siyouni) and Ace Impact (Cracksman) - the latter being named Cartier Horse of The Year in 2023.

## IRE: Lifetime breeding right in Blue Point goes for €480,000

A lifetime breeding right to Darley's former shuttle stallion Blue Point (Shamardal) sold for €480,000 (approx. AU\$782,470) on Monday. Sold via Darley's Winning Bid platform, the right went to an unnamed purchaser and followed on from another breeding right in the son of Shamardal (Giant's Causeway) that sold for €470,000 last month. Blue Point stood the 2026 northern hemisphere breeding season at Kildangan Stud for a fee of €100,000 (approx. AU\$163,010) and recently had Blue Bolt land both the Falmouth Stakes (Gr 1, 1m) and Prix Rothschild (Gr 1, 1600m). He shuttled to Darley Australia for four seasons between 2020-24 at a fee of \$44,000 (inc GST).

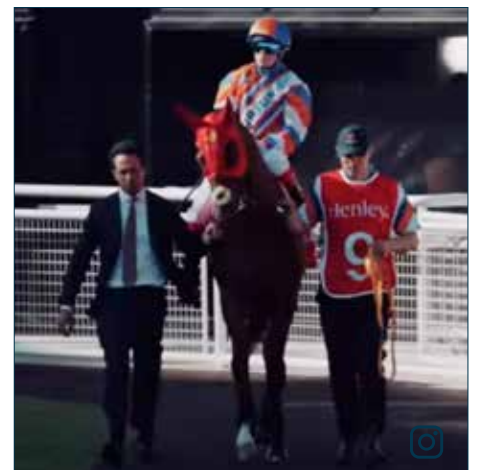
