Up And Coming hopefuls chase illustrious company

Saturday's Up And Coming Stakes (Gr 3, 1300m) has a history of providing an early spring launching pad for some of Australia's most talented three-year-olds and Sterling Alexiou hopes stakes-winning colt Southend (Palace Pier) can add his name to that list when he returns at Rosehill.

The Gerald Ryan and Alexiou-trained colt is among a fascinating group of three-year-olds converging on the \$250,000 contest, which features everything from

proven Group 1 performers to lightly raced youngsters taking their first steps into stakes company.

For Southend, Saturday represents the beginning of a campaign that could take him in several directions, with connections yet to determine whether his future lies around the shorter three-year-old features or over further later in the spring.

A winner on debut at Newcastle in March, Southend wasted little time announcing himself at stakes level when stepping straight up to land Rosehill's Baillieu Handicap (Gr 3, 1400m) at his second start.

Continued from page 1 That performance earned him a shot at the Champagne Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m), where he finished sixth behind Fireball (Snitzel), but Alexiou believes the son of Palace Pier (Kingman) had reached the end of his first preparation by that stage.

"We're still feeling our way with him in regards to what his best distance is going to be," Alexiou said.

"It was an end of prep run [in the Champagne Stakes]. He was up in trip, three weeks between runs and in a pretty strong race.

"He'll run on Saturday and then go to the Ming Dynasty [on September 12 at Rosehill],

then we'll work out if we go to a Golden Rose or a Caulfield Guineas, or a Dulcify [Stakes] and on to a Spring Champion Stakes.

"We'll know a lot more after Saturday, and a lot more after the Ming Dynasty."

Southend has been readied for his return with two trials, most recently defeating highly regarded filly Chayan (I Am Invincible), and Alexiou expects the colt to make his presence felt despite anticipating further improvement from the run.

The colt has drawn barrier nine, leaving connections likely to adopt patient tactics under Dylan Gibbons.

"That's probably the only disappointing thing. If he could have drawn a decent barrier, he would have had the option to race a bit handier," Alexiou said.

"Just that start is a bit tricky. We'll probably have to take our medicine, balance up, and he'll be finding the line well."

While Alexiou described Southend as a naturally robust colt who will benefit from

Saturday's outing, the trainer is eager to discover how much progress the three-year-old has made during his spell.

"I'm just really looking forward to getting him back to the races and seeing how much improvement he's made," Alexiou said.

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Continued from page 2 Waterhouse and Adrian Bott launching a three-pronged assault through Plagiarism (Written By) and Savabeel (Zabeel) pair Savagram and Savvy Diamond.

Like Southend, all three could use Saturday's contest as a stepping stone towards bigger spring assignments, although they arrive at Rosehill with contrasting levels of experience.

Plagiarism is the most seasoned of the Tulloch Lodge trio and Bott expects him to improve from his first-up third behind Steel Will (I Am Invincible) and Savvy Diamond at Rosehill earlier this month.

The son of Written By (Written Tycoon) carried 60 kilograms on that occasion and Bott believes a combination of the weight and tackling 1300 metres first-up told late.

"That wasn't the original first-up run for him. We had him in an easier maiden race option, so the 1300 first-up might have just told late with that weight, but the race had a good bit of depth to it," Bott said.

"He'll improve off it. He meets our other filly [Savvy Diamond] much better at the weights and he's in good order. He's got the benefit of having had a couple of racing seasons and preparations."

At the opposite end of the experience spectrum is the Waikato Stud-bred Savagram, a half-brother to 2023 Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) winner Major Beel who will be pitched into Group company at just his second start after making an immediate impression on debut.

The son of Waikato's late champion sire Savabeel was sent straight to the front at Canterbury earlier this month and never relinquished that advantage, producing a dominant performance that convinced connections the colt was ready for a significant rise in grade.

His pedigree and racing style give Tulloch Lodge reason to believe there is considerable

improvement to come as his distances increase, with the Spring Champion Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) already on the radar as a possible longer-term target.

"The Spring Champ could be the grand final we want to try to get to," Bott said.

"We are still step by step and we're going to keep it open and be a bit reactive in terms of where we go with him. The important thing is, he's ready to step up and hopefully that's what we keep seeing from him each run."

Savvy Diamond gives Waterhouse and Bott a third string to their bow and, like Savagram, only made her debut this month.

The filly made a winning debut at Goulburn on August 3 before stepping up sharply in grade when splitting Steel Will and Plagiarism at Rosehill under 52 kilograms.

While she remains a work in progress, Bott believes Saturday's race provides an ideal opportunity to give her further experience before she returns to fillies' company later in the spring.

"Her plan has always been to link back into the Princess Series once they step out to 1400 metres in the Tea Rose [Stakes], and then onto the Flight Stakes," Bott said.

"She still did a few things wrong last start, so that's why we wanted to give her a bit more racing experience in this grade before she links in with those better class fillies.

"She's up and going, she's got fitness on her side, and she ran well last start."

Chris Waller, meanwhile, will rely on Diameter (Brazen Beau) and Joint Venture (I Am Invincible), with the former bringing some of the strongest juvenile form into Saturday's contest.

Diameter broke through at stakes level when successful in the Fernhill Mile (Listed, 1600m) during the autumn before backing up a week later to finish third in the Champagne Stakes.

That Group 1 placing sees him resume with 61 kilograms at the top of the weights, but despite both his stakes win and elite-level placing coming over a mile, Waller expects the son of Brazen Beau (I Am Invincible) to possess enough sharpness to be competitive over Saturday's shorter trip.

"He's Group 1-placed over a mile, and a winner over a mile, but he's by Brazen Beau so I think he'll find some speed and be competitive first-up," Waller said.

Continued from page 3 Stablemate Joint Venture makes the leap into Group company having had just two starts.

The I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit) colt finished third on debut before breaking his maiden with a determined performance on a heavy Rosehill track in July and will carry the minimum weight as he attempts to take another step through the grades.

For all the established stakes form represented by Southend and Diameter, and the emerging potential of others, the horse they may all have to overcome is one whose significance extends beyond Saturday's result.

Genesis Runner (Gun Runner), trained by Richard and Will Freedman, arrives at his first stakes assignment as the \$4.20 market elect and the sole Australian representative to have raced for one of North America's most influential stallions.

The Yulong-owned colt created a piece of history when becoming the first Australian runner and winner for Three Chimneys Farm's Gun Runner (Candy Ride) with an impressive victory at Newcastle in June.

Fourth on debut at the same venue earlier that month, Genesis Runner took a significant step forward at start two, cruising to a 2.3-length victory over 1300 metres.

That performance was also notable given he defeated older opposition and came on a Heavy 8 surface, while the colt has subsequently been given time to develop ahead of his three-year-old campaign.

Genesis Runner has shown his wellbeing at the trials, winning his two most recent hit-outs, and will resume from barrier one under Kerrin McEvoy.

A \$575,000 purchase by Yulong from Widden Stud's draft at the 2025 Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale, Genesis Runner is out of the stakes-placed Artie Schiller (El Prado) mare Originator.

However, it is the presence of Gun Runner on the top line of his pedigree that makes his progress particularly intriguing from an Australian bloodstock perspective.

The son of Candy Ride (Ride The Rails) was an outstanding racehorse in the US, winning 12 of his 19 starts and six Grade 1 races, headed by the Breeders' Cup Classic (Gr 1, 10f) and

Pegasus World Cup Invitational (Gr 1, 9f).

His achievements at stud have been equally notable.

Standing at his Kentucky base for US\$250,000 (approx. AU\$347,230) in 2026, Gun Runner has produced 61 stakes winners from 528 runners at 11.6 per cent, including 15 at the elite level.

His success has also translated to the sales ring, where his yearlings have regularly commanded seven-figure prices, including at the recent Saratoga Select Yearling Sale where his colt out of stakes-winning mare Four Graces (Majesticperfection) sold for US\$4 million (approx. AU\$5.55 million) to become the second top lot.

Genesis Runner is one of only three Australian-bred members of his crop and a stakes victory at just his third career start would therefore give the colt another important first, providing Gun Runner with an Australian stakes winner from extremely limited representation, potentially adding a new international dimension to his already formidable stud record.

It would also be fitting if that milestone came in the Up And Coming Stakes.

Since its inaugural running in 1979, the race has repeatedly identified horses destined to make a significant impact both on the track and at stud.

Few renewals illustrate that better than the extraordinary sequence at the beginning of this century.

Exceed And Excel (Danahill) won the race in 2003 before developing into a dual Group 1-winning sprinter and subsequently one of Darley's most important stallions.

A year later it was Fastnet Rock (Danahill) who broke his maiden in the Up And Coming, with the future dual champion sire going on to win the Lightning Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m) and Oakleigh Plate (Gr 1, 1100m) before embarking on an outstanding stud career at Coolmore.

Snitzel (Redoute's Choice) added his name to the honour roll in 2005 and would ultimately eclipse even his considerable achievements on the track during a record-breaking career at Arrowfield Stud.

More recent winners have also used the race as a springboard towards elite company.

Divine Prophet (Choisir) landed the Up And Coming in 2016 before winning the Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) three starts later, while the 2017 renewal proved an exceptional pointer to the spring in a race won by Dracarys (Snitzel). That field included subsequent Golden Rose (Gr 1, 1400m) winner Trapeze Artist (Snitzel) and Ace High (High Chaparral), who went on to complete the Spring Champion Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m)-Victoria Derby (Gr 1, 2500m) double.

North Pacific (Brazen Beau) announced himself as a high-class colt with a dominant victory in 2020, while the race again unearthed a star two years ago when Autumn Glow (The Autumn Sun) became the first filly to win the contest.

The Waller-trained now five-year-old was having just her second start when defeating the males at Rosehill and has lost just once in her following 11 starts – with four wins coming at the top level.

Tom Kitten (Harry Angel) and Grand Prairie (Written Tycoon) are among the other recent names on an honour roll that also features Testa Rossa (Perugino) and General Nediym (Nediym).

Crowned Australian Racehorse Of The Year on Thursday evening, the Chris Waller-trained five-year-old had been attracting a lot of interest for a slot in the \$20 million Everest, but following a meeting between Messara, Waller and jockey James McDonald, the King Charles has been decided as the most suitable option. "We looked closely at The Everest and there was a part of me that wanted to try and beat Ka Ying Rising," Messara said. "But the reality is Ka Ying Rising is as good as any sprinter I've ever seen and 1200 metres is his best distance. We all feel Autumn Glow is at her best between 1400 metres and 1600 metres so it was agreed we should go for the King Charles." Won last year by Ceowulf (Tavistock), the 2026 King Charles III Stakes will take place on October 17.

Jimmy out to star in Memsie

Ciaran Maher is confident that his three-time Group 1 winner Jimmysstar (Per Incanto) can 'make his presence felt' when the seven-year-old takes to Caulfield's Memsie Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) on Saturday. Last seen running second in the Kingsford-Smith Cup (Gr 1, 1300m), the son of Per Incanto (Street Cry) will be returning to Caulfield for the first time since finishing seventh in the William Reid Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m), an effort that followed on from a win in the C.F. Orr Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at the same track. "His two jump-outs have been very sharp this prep and I'm just rapt with the way he's come up," Maher said. "You could say his runs in the autumn were not right up to his best, but he seems to have come back really well and seems in a good spot. I'm really looking forward

to kicking off in the Memsie. The 1400 [metres] is arguably his best trip at the moment and Caulfield, he's got a great record as well. He's raced the best plenty of times. He was very good against Ka Ying Rising over six [furlongs] and you would think he's better over seven. He's got a good base and has come up well and I'm sure he will make his presence felt."

Deakin kicks off Caulfield Cup campaign

The OTI Racing-owned Deakin (Australia) will kick off his campaign in Saturday's Heatherlie Stakes (Listed, 1700m) at Caulfield as father-and-son trainers Phillip and Tommy Stokes again aim for the Caulfield Cup (Gr 1, 2400m). A seven-year-old Irish import, the son of Australia (Galileo) landed both the Torney Night Cup (Listed, 2500m) and Roy Higgins Quality (Listed, 2600m) last season before then running a respectable eighth in the Caulfield Cup, and the Group 1 on October 17 is firmly in sight again. "He had his second trial at Caulfield last week," Phillip Stokes said. "He hasn't raced since the Bart Cummings Stakes in Adelaide, and we pulled up after that, so it's nearly been a year off, but I'm feeling he's going as well as ever. Last prep, first-up 1400 metres, so the 1700 suits this time first-up, but I think he will need the run just to bring him on for his second-up assignment, but I couldn't have been any happier with his trial. We're doing a similar campaign again to the Caulfield Cup."

Baker duo ready for San Domenico

Warwick Farm-based trainer Bjorn Baker will send out a pair of runners in Saturday's San Domenico Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) at Rosehill. Promising pair Blue Door (Stay Inside) and Warwoven (Sword Of State) will take to the

track, with the former looking to build upon a win in the Kindergarten Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) and runner-up effort in The Rosebud (Listed, 1100m) from two starts to date. "She only had one trial going into that race [The Rosebud] so I think she will be fitter, her work on Tuesday was excellent and she looks well," Baker told Racing NSW. "From that point of view we can't fault her, she's a fast filly. She's second-up, I guess we're still learning about her. There's no hiding, it's a tough race whatever way you look at it. It's not a gimme by any means." Jockey Rachel King has switched from Blue Door to Warwoven, who she has ridden in all five of his previous outings - including for a win in the Pago Pago Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m). "I think he will be better when he gets over a touch further but he's shown he's good at the shorter trips previously and has plenty of speed," Baker said. "My gut feel is we will put him where he's comfortable and hopefully he will be strong late."

Patience key to Revengeance spring return

Last-start Golden Gift (1100m) winner Revengeance (Hellbent) will make his return in Saturday's San Domenico Stakes at Rosehill. Having won the Golden Gift in November, the three-year-old colt was ruled out of the autumn due to surgery to remove bone chips from a knee. Instead of sending the son of Hellbent (I Am Invincible) to The Rosebud, Bott and training partner Gai Waterhouse opted to wait for this weekend's assignment. "We trialled instead. He'd had a long time off and I didn't want to rush him back," Bott said. "Plus he would have had to carry a bit of weight with his Golden Gift win. He will be better suited in the San Domenico. He looks fantastic. He's come back really well and he is stretching out nicely. It might be a bit short for him. I think he'll be a lovely horse as he gets out to 1400 and 1600 metres."

Kearney searching for key to Chief Little Rock

Having purchased Irish Group 3 winner Chief Little Rock (Galileo) for \$42,500 via the 2026 Inglis May (Early) Online Sale, trainer Patrick Kearney is hoping that the former Aidan O'Brien-trained gelding can land his first

success in Australia. The six-year-old will tackle the Sportsbet Green Tick Handicap (2500m) at Morphettville on Saturday and has made one start for Kearney to be fifth over 2400 metres at Sandown-Hillside, having had a stint at Anthony and Sam Freedman's previously. "This preparation we're just working him out and spending time, finding his groove, and then next prep hopefully will be the making of him," Kearney said. "He'll probably go down to Tasmania for the Cups if he's showing enough ability to be able to do that. He does have the ability. He was always going to be a project to see if we could find it [form] and find the bottom of the horse. He was brought over here with higher expectations which he hasn't exceeded yet. Hopefully we can get him right and eventually he can run in some of these nice races."

Expensive Snitzel colts catch eyes at Randwick trials

High-priced Snitzel (Redoute's Choice) colts St Gotthard and The Next Episode crossed paths for the first time as three-year-olds when both caught the eye during a star-studded set of trials at Randwick on Friday. The Chris Waller-trained St Gotthard, a \$2.7 million purchase at the Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale, won the 1045-metre heat in good style to maintain his progression towards a spring campaign, defeating Asgarda (The Brothers War) by 0.8 lengths. Three-time stakes winner King Of Roseau (Capitalist) was another 0.7 lengths back in third. Unbeaten in two starts, St Gotthard is a brother to Coolmore Stud Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner and Coolmore stallion Switzerland. Meanwhile, The Next Episode, a \$2.8 million Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale purchase, was kept under a hold to finish three lengths behind St Gotthard in sixth. The Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott-trained

colt finished second in the Kindergarten Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) before winning his next two starts in Queensland, including the Magic Millions National 2yo Classic (1000m). Elsewhere, a host of Group 1 stars continued their spring preparations, with newly crowned Australian Champion Sprinter Joliestar (Zoustar) appearing alongside Tron Bolt (Toronado), Fireball (Snitzel) and Australian Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) winner Panova (Trapeze Artist) in a xx-metre heat won by Way To The Stars (Reward For Effort). Headley Grange (Exosphere) finished second in that trial, while Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott's Sir Delius (Frankel) continued his spring build-up with victory in his 1200-metre heat under Craig Williams.

RWWA announces CEO leadership transition

Racing and Wagering Western Australia (RWWA) chief executive officer Ian Edwards has advised the board of his decision to step down from the role. Edwards will remain with RWWA until November 13, 2026 to support a smooth and orderly transition. RWWA board chair Karen Farley SC thanked Edwards for his leadership and contribution to the organisation and the Western Australian racing industry. "Ian has led RWWA through a significant period of transformation, growth and innovation," Farley said. "During his tenure, RWWA delivered a number of landmark initiatives, including the launch of the TABtouch Western Trilogy - the world's only tri-codeslot race series - expanded the reach of WA racing through new broadcast and distribution partnerships, including the launch of Racing WA TV, and continued to innovate the WA TAB to ensure it remains competitive in an increasingly dynamic wagering market. On behalf of the board, I thank Ian for his leadership and dedication to racing and wagering in Western Australia. We are grateful for his ongoing commitment to supporting a smooth transition over the coming months."

Prize-money boost to Northern Queensland Winter Racing Carnival

The Northern Queensland Winter Racing Carnival will go to another level in 2027, with a boost in prize-money to see almost \$3.5 million go up for grabs over two months of racing. All four major Cups races held across Rockhampton, Mackay, Townsville and Cairns will now be run for \$200,000 each, an increase of \$50,000 for each race. Being run for \$75,000 each in 2026, the four Guineas races held across the same cities will now offer prize-money of \$100,000 in each race. Additionally, the Mackay Newmarket (1300m) will now be run for \$100,000 to bring it in line with the prize-money on offer in the Northern Carnival's other feature sprints. "The Northern Queensland Winter Racing Carnival continues to go from strength to strength, and this investment is a clear vote of confidence in the clubs, participants and communities that make it such a special part of the Queensland racing calendar," acting Racing Queensland CEO Lachlan Murray said. "With more than \$3 million in prize-money on offer in 2027, there will be added incentive for owners, trainers and jockeys to target the carnival and showcase their horses across Rockhampton, Mackay, Townsville and Cairns. The carnival plays an important role in supporting the racing industry across Central and North Queensland, driving visitation, generating local economic activity and creating opportunities for regional participants to compete."

Zafar to kick off Guineas preparation

Te Akau Racing will unveil a number of their spring prospects at Riccarton on Saturday, headed by unbeaten stakes-winning colt Zafar (Snitzel), who begins his path towards the New

Zealand 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m). The Mark Walker and Sam Bergerson-trained three-year-old won the Champagne Stakes (Listed, 1200m) at his only juvenile start and returns in the Three-Year-Old (1000m). "He's had a trial and then we took him to Ashburton for a gallop last Friday for a day out and he's coming along well," Te Akau assistant trainer Hunter Durrant said. "He's ready to run over 1000 metres. It might be a touch short for him at the current point in his prep, but he's only going to improve. The Heavy track is a bit concerning, but I think class will take him a long way." Zafar will clash with stablemate and Welcome Stakes (Listed, 1000m) winner Enchantment (Hello Youmzain). "She is a stakes-winning filly and she's coming up well," Durrant said.

Marsh hunting further Guineas honours

Cambridge trainer Stephen Marsh will launch the spring campaigns of promising fillies So Fear (Ardrossan) and Perfect Chaos (Hello Youmzain) in Saturday's Wanganui Guineas (Listed, 1200m), with both mares on a path towards the New Zealand 1,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m). The pair return following productive juvenile seasons, with So Fear winning two of her first three starts, including placing in the Star Way Stakes (Listed, 1200m), while Perfect Chaos has yet to finish outside the placings in four appearances. Marsh said he has been pleased with the way both fillies have returned.

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"I'm thrilled with them, they had good campaigns at the backend of their two-year-old seasons," he said. "So Fear was very good, she won two in a row and was stakes-placed, and Perfect Chaos was probably unlucky not to win a race, but her worst race was third and never actually put in a bad race. They have both come back well, they have had the one trial, and you just hope the track keeps on improving. I think they're going into it forward and ready, and I think they get through a bit of rain." Marsh won last year's 1,000 Guineas with Well Written (Written Tycoon) and expects both fillies to follow a similar route towards Riccarton.

Williams to bow out at Riccarton

Kylie Williams will bring the curtain down on a 30-year riding career at Riccarton on Saturday, fittingly at the track where she rode in her first race as a 16-year-old in 1996. Williams heads into her final meeting with 1,019 victories and 32 stakes wins, having celebrated her 1,000th winner at Riccarton last September. "I had my first ride there on [New Zealand] Cup Day in 1996," Williams said. "It's not my favourite track, but my family are all going to be there, and it will be quite nice to finish up at Riccarton." Among the highlights of Williams' career was riding against her son, Victorian-based apprentice Logan Bates, during last year's New Zealand Cup Week. "I never encouraged it, but he's flying and I'm very proud. It was pretty cool to ride against him," she said. Williams was also trackside when Bates secured his first elite-level success aboard Jigsaw (Manhattan Rain) in the Railway (Gr 1, 1200m) at Ellerslie.

The Cantabrian will remain involved in racing, beginning her new role as New Zealand Thoroughbred Racing's South Island Riding Mentor on Monday. "I think it will be harder trying to teach them than riding my own race," she said. "It will be another learning curve. It will definitely make me proud when I see them out there accomplishing things." Williams has seven rides on Saturday, including What She Wants (Almanzor) in the appropriately named Celebrating Kylie Williams (1800m). "I think she's probably my best chance," Williams said.

"Estrange suffered some bone bruising during her last race, which meant she's had to have an easy time since and, although an autumn campaign was being envisaged, time is running out to have her fully fit, therefore Mrs Thompson feels, as she's won her Group 1, it is time for her to retire to the paddocks," Cheveley Park managing director Chris Richardson told the Racing Post.

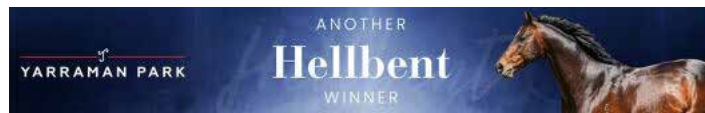
