## American Eagle adds another feather to MyRacehorse cap

MyRacehorse's remarkably productive bloodstock model unearthed another potential spring star on Saturday when unbeaten colt American Eagle (Too Darn Hot) maintained his perfect record with a victory in the McNeil Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) at Caulfield.

The Anthony and Sam Freedman-trained three-year-old arrived at the meeting with just

one start to his name, having scored over 1200 metres at Sandown in July, but made the sizable leap into stakes company with aplomb under Mark Zahra.

American Eagle burst clear in the straight before holding off the late challenge of Magic Millions 2YO Classic (RL, 1200m) winner Unit Five (Supido), announcing himself as another serious prospect for a MyRacehorse operation which has enjoyed an enviable return from its yearling selections in recent seasons.

### Morning Briefing

#### Vale Bev Kelso

New Zealand racing is in mourning following the death of respected Matamata trainer Bev Kelso, aged 80, who passed away on Saturday following a period of illness.

Kelso trained in partnership with husband Ken, the pair associated with a succession of outstanding mares, most recently multiple Group 1 winners Legarto (Proisir) and Levante (Proisir), as well as current sprint star Alabama Lass (Alabama Express).

The Kelsos had trained together since 1978, and Legarto provided a special moment for the family in Bev's final days when the recently retired mare was named Matamata Horse of the Year at the region's annual awards on Thursday night.

**Continued from page 2** For MyRacehorse chief executive Ben Willis, the result was further vindication of a system spearheaded by respected agent Damon Gabbedy and built around collaboration with the trainers entrusted with preparing the syndicator's horses.

"Damon Gabbedy runs our bloodstock team. He leads, with myself and Emma Freedman primarily, and we've got a few other people in the mix," Willis told ANZ News.

"When we go to a sale, we'll partner up with four or five different stables that we have horses with.

"We'll combine and collaborate on shortlists and then go in to bid for them, get them vetted, et cetera. So that's what we've done the last three years of sales, and it's worked quite well."

Quite well may be an understatement.

From its 2024 yearling crop alone, MyRacehorse emerged with the likes of Flight Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) heroine Apocalyptic (Extreme Choice), recent Missile Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) winner Ninja (Farnan), Breeders' Plate (Gr 3, 1000m) scorer King Kirk (Ole Kirk), and Tulloch Stakes (Gr 2, 2000m) winner Storm Leopard (Ghaiyyath) among a cohort that delivered an exceptional rate of black-type success.

"In 2024, we landed Apocalyptic, Ninja, Storm Leopard, King Kirk – stakes winners," Willis said.

"We were hitting about 50 per cent stakes winners to runners from that yearling sale. Three of those horses are still really exciting with what they're going to be able to do this spring ahead."

American Eagle was sourced from the

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following year's Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale, where the son of Darley shuttler Too Darn Hot (Dubawi) was offered by Yulong as Lot 184.

**Continued from page 3** The colt was one Willis said ticked many of the boxes which underpin the MyRacehorse selection process, beginning with the presence he displayed during inspections.

"I think the main thing that we really loved about him is – and you see it on race day – he's just got a really strong presence about him," Willis said.

"He's not an overly heavy colt, but he's not

small by any means either. He's strong. He's physical. He's a nice free-moving type, well balanced, well proportioned.

"And then when you overlay him on type and then you look at his pedigree – Too Darn Hot was on fire at the time. They were absolutely sizzling on the track; we had one as well called Charcoals, who had chalked up quite a few wins for our ownership group.

"I think it was announced that he was going to shuttle back to Australia. We wanted to get involved in another one regardless."

The bottom half of American Eagle's pedigree provided another attraction.

He is the third foal out of the Redoute's Choice (Danehill) mare Awake The Stars, whose earlier progeny included Stardealt (Dundeel), a winner over a mile and third in the 2024 Tasmanian Derby (Listed, 2200m).

Willis has long been an admirer of Redoute's Choice mares and believed the combination with Too Darn Hot provided further encouragement. **Continued on page 7**

"I love Redoute's Choice mares," he said. "I reckon, when I think back through Anamoe, Artorius, Hitotsu – he's just got such a good conversion rate as a broodmare sire. So I like that side.

"The mare had already thrown a mile winner, Stardealt, who was third in a Tassie Derby; American Eagle is her third foal.

"So it was ticking all those boxes that we really look for, and then him coming out of the Yulong draft. Yulong is obviously such a global powerhouse and respected breeding operation, and we like buying off good farms and from good breeders."

While American Eagle had made his way onto the shortlists of both MyRacehorse and the Freedman team, securing the colt proved rather less straightforward.

Bloodstock agent Julian Blaxland, who works closely with the Freedman stable and MyRacehorse, had identified him during his first inspections of the catalogue.

"He instantly took my eye on first inspections," Blaxland told ANZ.

"I ran through the whole catalogue before I gave it to all the boys, Anthony and Sam Freedman, and he was a lovely horse.

"We vetted him, he made the final list and we watched him go through. MyRacehorse was there and they've had good success with the Freedmans – both Anthony and Sam, Richard and Will, and Michael – and Sam and Ben are very close.

"They get horses from MyRacehorse, and they wanted to take a big chunk of a colt like this. They buy those types of good-pedigree colts by hot stallions."

When American Eagle entered the ring on the opening day of the sale, however, he failed to meet his \$400,000 reserve.

MyRacehorse had been involved in the bidding on the colt in conjunction with another stable, but Willis said their interest had stopped at \$350,000.

"We went and bid on him with this other

stable, and we went up to \$350,000," Willis said.

"He ended up getting passed in, and the reserve was \$400,000. We tried to do a deal with them to come back, but they're like, 'Nah, \$400,000 or nothing.'

"This particular stable wasn't willing to go up, which is fair enough. At the yearling sales, you just move on to the next one."

But the colt had also remained firmly on the radar of Blaxland and the Freedmans.

Blaxland approached Yulong chief operating officer Sam Fairgray in an effort to strike a deal after the colt left the ring, and an agreement was reached later in the week.

"We initially watched the horse pass in on the first day of the sale, and I went on behalf of our team and tried to negotiate a deal on him with Sam Fairgray at the time," Blaxland said.

"We then watched a few other similar colts on the lists to do with MyRacehorse over the next couple of days, and we managed to get the horse done on the Thursday. Continued on page 8

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**Continued from page 7** “In hindsight, I’m glad we were patient and I’m glad we managed to get him done. We were beaten on a couple of other ones, but this horse was still there on the Thursday.

“Everyone came to the party, did the deal and the rest is history. It’s certainly been a really exciting start for him.”

For Willis, the final piece of the puzzle fell into place away from the ring.

Attending a Magic Millions event hosted by the Freedman stable, Willis learnt a deal had been struck whereby Yulong would retain an interest in the colt, with the remaining share available to outside investors.

“That night I was at Sam and Anthony’s stable event, they were running a Magic Millions stable event, and they were talking about this colt that they’ve just partnered in with Yulong, and if anyone’s willing to take 50 per cent, you can get colours,” Willis said.

“That’s the deal they had done with Yulong. So they had all done it on our behalf, and we were going to get a horse with them regardless.

“We work with Julian Blaxland a lot and I knew he was across it, Sam [Freedman] was across it. We all loved the colt.

“So I just went up to Sam at that event that night and said, ‘We’ll take the other 50 per cent, lock him in.’ And so that’s how we came about acquiring him with MyRacehorse.”

It was an unconventional route to ownership of the colt, but one which has already proved worthwhile.

“It can be a little bit risky. It was pretty funny that it’s turned out to be American Eagle,” Willis said.

“Yulong has been great. We’ve obviously done quite a bit with them since with this horse, and they’ve been great partners and great to work with.”

American Eagle’s emergence has also provided a rewarding result for Yulong, both as the breeder which raised and offered the colt and as a continuing shareholder.

Fairgray said the youngster had been held in high regard well before arriving at the Gold Coast.

“He was a great physical and had always been a nice horse from the time we had him,” Fairgray told ANZ.

“Too Darn Hot was all the rage at the time and this colt oozed quality and class. We were very happy to stay in with the Freedman stable.”

Blaxland believes the outcome has ultimately suited every party.

“Yulong kept a piece, so it worked out well in the end for everyone,” he said. “I’m sure Yulong is happy to still have a piece in him today.”

The transaction also continued beyond American Eagle himself. Yulong subsequently sold Awake The Stars privately, despite the mare having produced a colt the operation clearly valued.

The subsequent emergence of her Too Darn Hot (Dubawi) colt may carry a hint of what might have been for his breeder, but Yulong’s retained interest means it has hardly been left empty-handed.

And after just two starts, the upside in American Eagle could be considerable.

Willis said the colt went into his first stakes assignment short of peak fitness, with the Caulfield Guineas Prelude (Gr 3, 1400m) on September 27 having long been pencilled in as the next stage of his preparation.

“The plan was always going into this race, he was only about 80, 85 per cent fit,” Willis said.

“The plan was always to go to the Guineas Prelude. That was going to give him a good chance to step up to 1400 metres.

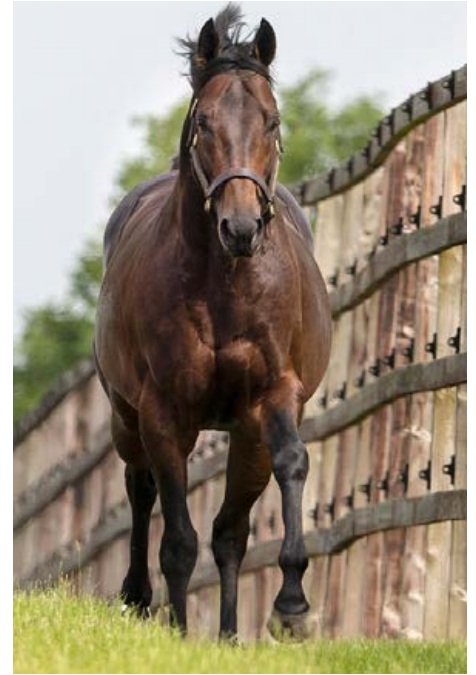
“We’ve been a bit on the fence whether he’s a Coolmore Stud Stakes type, 1200-metre/ six-furlong horse, or a Caulfield Guineas type miler. It’s a good problem to have.

“The plan is to step him up to 1400 metres and see how he handles that step up in trip.”

His pedigree and Mark Zahra’s feedback following Saturday’s victory provided encouragement that the colt’s relaxed racing style could allow him to stretch beyond sprint trips.

“Mark seems to think he relaxes well enough that he’d be able to stretch out to that distance,” Willis said.

“We’re still learning about him. That would almost be the fork-in-the-road race where we go, do we push on to the Guineas and go up another 200 metres, or do we pull him back for the Coolmore Stud Stakes on Derby Day?”

Whichever direction American Eagle takes, he may not be the only member of MyRacehorse’s latest crop capable of enhancing the operation’s already impressive record.

Willis nominated Platinum Pearl, a Frankel (Galileo) filly also sourced from Yulong, and the Bjorn Baker-trained The Autumn Sun (Redoute’s Choice) filly Pacifico as two others with considerable upside.

“He [American Eagle] was one of four [purchased on the Gold Coast]. Platinum Pearl, a grey Frankel filly out of the Yulong draft as well, she debuted on Wednesday at Sandown about two weeks ago, 1200 metres, ran third behind a gun,” he said.

“She’ll map a plan towards ideally a VRC Oaks or a Thousand Guineas, and then we’ve got another Autumn Sun filly with Bjorn called Pacifico, who’s just finished up her trials and is about to have her debut racing campaign, who looks pretty neat as well.”

Emboldened by the results generated by the system Gabbedy and the wider bloodstock team have developed, MyRacehorse has increased its investment again this year.

“This year we’ve really backed our bloodstock system with Emma and Damon,” Willis said. “We’ve bought 15 yearlings, so I think the 2026 two-year-olds will hopefully mean a lot more horses hitting the track and winning races in years to come.”

### Lot 1 - Private Eye share closes Monday

Bidding for the unreserved ten per cent share in Group 1 winner Private Eye (Al Maher) will close at 12pm AEST on Monday, August 31, ahead of the remainder of the latest Magic Millions Digital catalogue. Offered by Proven Thoroughbreds as agent and catalogued as Lot 1, the share has been placed on the market after the organisation which owns it, the Tatts Club, was placed into administration. Private Eye currently sits tenth on the all-time Australian prize-money earners list and began his spring campaign with a runner-up finish in the P B Lawrence Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) at Caulfield on August 15. The Joe Pride-trained nine-year-old is expected to have his next start in either the Tramway Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) at Randwick or the Theo Marks Stakes (Gr 2, 1300m) at Rosehill. "Private Eye has changed many lives and this is a rare opportunity to buy into a proper Group 1 horse and enjoy the ride," Proven Thoroughbreds' Tom Walter said. "We anticipate he will continue his fine form this spring and race into the autumn." Bidding for the remainder of the catalogue, from Lot 2 onwards, will close from 12pm AEST on Wednesday, September 2.

### Basil Nolan inducted into Queensland Racing Hall of Fame

Respected thoroughbred breeder and industry leader Basil Nolan has been formally inducted into the Queensland Racing Hall of Fame, recognising more than six decades of contribution to the state's breeding and racing industries.

Nolan was inducted alongside former jockey Jim Byrne, champion racehorse Planet Ruler (Kaoru Star) and trainer Jack Booth.

The 80-year-old has spent much of his life at his family's Raheen Stud near Warwick on the Darling Downs, joining his parents in the operation in 1963 before developing the farm alongside his wife Diane into one of Queensland's best-known breeding operations.

Nolan's contribution has extended well beyond Raheen. He first joined the Thoroughbred Breeders Queensland Association committee in 1969, served as president from 1980 to 1991 and returned to the position in 2010.

During his tenure, he has advocated for initiatives including enhancements to the Queensland Thoroughbred Incentive

Scheme and breeders' bonuses, while also supporting equine welfare and rehoming through the Queensland Off-The-Track Board.

At a national level, Nolan has represented Queensland on the Thoroughbred Breeders Australia board since its establishment in 2005 and has served as president since 2014.

"It's unbelievable - I truly never expected to be in the Queensland Racing Hall of Fame," Nolan said. "It's not just an honour for me, it's for the thoroughbred breeders in Queensland and the people that make it up, alongside my wife who is my backbone."

Nolan has also been a prominent advocate for breeders during major industry challenges, including the equine influenza outbreak, the 2011 Queensland floods and the COVID-19 pandemic.

Earlier in his career he spent 22 years as a bookmaker at Eagle Farm, experience which later informed his involvement in discussions around race fields legislation and prize-money distribution.

To mark his induction, TBQA presented Basil and Diane Nolan with an original artwork by Toowoomba-based artist Kelly Charles.

## Chairman's Sale-topper Chayan set for spring return

Record-priced filly Chayan (I Am Invincible) will make her spring return in Saturday's Furious Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) at Randwick, four months after Coolmore paid \$5.6 million for her at the Inglis Chairman's Sale. The Annabel and Rob Archibald-trained three-year-old was purchased by Coolmore in May, having established significant residual value through victory in the Reisling Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) back in March. Chayan is out of stakes-winning Snitzel (Redoute's Choice) mare Lubiton, a granddaughter of Coolmore Classic (Gr 1, 1500m) winner Camino Rose (Sea Road). Chayan returned to Rosehill for a race-day gallop last Saturday, with Zac Lloyd aboard in the absence of regular rider James McDonald. "She was really good and we just wanted to bring her out and get rid of that nervous energy," Annabel Archibald said. "She didn't need to do a whole lot because physically she is fairly forward anyway." Chayan has pleased in two trials ahead of her return and McDonald retains the ride despite partnering Silver Shadow Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) winner Pembrey (Prague) at her most recent start. The stable plans to progress Chayan through 1200 metres and then 1400 metres before determining whether she continues towards the Flight Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) at Randwick on October 3.

## Four-timer adds to Zousain's strong start

Widden Stud's Zousain (Zoustar) continued his strong start to the new season with four winners on Saturday, taking his tally to 19 individual winners of 22 races for August, with only So You Think (High Chaparral) and his own sire Zoustar (Northern Meteor) having produced more Australian winners so far this season. At this rate, Zousain will comfortably reach the 100-winner milestone coming off a strong 2025/26 season in which he finished as Australia's leading third-season sire by winners (96) headed by stakes winners Verzain and Catch The Glory. His worldwide tally reached 105, including three in New Zealand and six in Hong Kong, where he'll have over 20 runners in the coming season. Three of Saturday's quartet came at metropolitan level, headed by

## Spicy Martini crowned Queensland Horse of the Year

Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1400m) winner Spicy Martini (Justify) was crowned Queensland Horse of the Year at the 2026 Queensland Thoroughbred Awards, headlining 27 awards presented on Sunday.

The Toby Edmonds-trained five-year-old secured the state's top honour following a season highlighted by her breakthrough Group 1 victory in the Stradbroke at Eagle Farm, which came at just her 12th career start.

Spicy Martini also finished runner-up in the Doomben 10,000 (Gr 1, 1200m) and won the Ascot Handicap (Listed, 1000m) during the season.

She was additionally recognised as Queensland's Four-Year-Old and Older Horse of the Year.

Acting Racing Queensland chief executive Lachlan Murray said Spicy Martini's award reflected an outstanding campaign.

"Spicy Martini claiming the code's top honour is thoroughly deserved following a remarkable win in the Stradbroke Handicap, where she became the first Queensland-trained horse to win our great race since 2020," Murray said.

Jockey Taylor Marshall's winning ride aboard Spicy Martini in the Stradbroke earned him the Darby McCarthy Performance of the Year award.

Tony Gollan, fresh from a quintet of winners at Eagle Farm on Saturday, extended his remarkable dominance of Queensland racing, receiving the Jim Atkins Trainer of the Year award for the 13th consecutive season.

Gollan saddled 213 winners across Queensland and secured the Metropolitan Trainers' Premiership with 147 victories. His stable's emerging filly Pembrey (Prague) was named Queensland Two-Year-Old Horse of the Year following a juvenile campaign that included victory in the Magic Night Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) and a start in the Golden Slipper (Gr 1, 1200m).

Son of new Eureka Stud recruit Graff (Star Witness), Grafterburners claimed Three-Year-Old Horse of the Year honours after compiling four consecutive victories, culminating in the Magic Millions Sunlight 3YO Plate (1100m) in January.

Veteran sprinter Rothfire (Rothsay) was named QTIS Horse of the Year following his memorable victory in the Doomben 10,000, while also being among the finalists for the overall Horse of the Year award.

Ben Thompson received the George Moore Queensland Jockey of the Year award after winning the Metropolitan Jockeys' Premiership with 99.5 victories, while Jace McMurray was named the Ken Russell Queensland Apprentice of the Year after riding 49 winners statewide and securing the Metropolitan Apprentice Jockey Premiership.

Four new members were also inducted into the Queensland Racing Hall of Fame.

Former jockey Jim Byrne was recognised following a career that produced more than 2,900 winners, seven Group 1 victories and multiple Queensland premierships.

Champion galloper Planet Ruler (Kaoru Star) was also inducted, having won ten consecutive metropolitan races in Queensland during the late 1980s and a Group 1 race in five successive seasons, including the 1992 Honda Stakes, now the Champions Mile (Gr 1, 1600m), as an eight-year-old.

Trainer Jack Booth, a dominant figure in Queensland racing during the 1920s, was honoured posthumously, while respected breeder and long-time industry administrator Basil Nolan was recognised for more than six decades of service to the Queensland thoroughbred industry.

Zalique, who took his record to three wins from five starts with an impressive Highway victory at Rosehill for Matt Dunn. Howdoyouzou won the opening race at Eagle Farm for Pat Webster, recording his third win from six starts, while the Aaron Bain and Ned Taylor-trained Leading Impact registered his third success from six outings at Morphettville.

## My Gladiola aims for another Royal Ascot invite

Dual Group 1 runner-up My Gladiola (I Am Invincible) is set to return to Sandown for a second jumpout on Tuesday ahead of a possible first-up tilt at Saturday's Moir Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m), with trainer John McArdle eyeing an eventual Royal Ascot campaign. The four-year-old I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit) mare established herself among Australia's leading young sprinters last season, finishing runner-up to Tentyris (Street Boss) in both the Coolmore Stud Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) and Black Caviar Lightning Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m). Those performances earned the filly an invitation to Royal Ascot, which connections declined, but McArdle has indicated a trip to Britain is firmly on the agenda next year. My Gladiola impressed in a Sandown jumpout last week, defeating Everest winner Giga Kick (Scissor Kick) despite conditions being wetter than preferred. Should she take her place and perform, the Manikato Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) is among the options later in the spring, with Royal Ascot the long-term objective.

## Queensland stallion honours shared by Lyndhurst and Eureka

Lyndhurst Stud enjoyed a strong result in the Thoroughbred Breeders Queensland Association's annual awards, with Better Than Ready (More Than Ready) crowned Queensland Champion Stallion for a fourth consecutive season and stud mate Barbaric (I Am Invincible) taking Champion First Season Stallion honours.

Better Than Ready continued his position at the head of Queensland's stallion ranks during 2025/26, siring 128 winners of 220 races from 278 runners, with four individual stakes winners and progeny earnings of \$10.37 million.

The son of More Than Ready (Southern Halo) has become a cornerstone of Lyndhurst Stud's stallion roster since retiring to the Darling Downs farm. His leading performer was Chidiac, who won seven of her 13 starts during the season and earned more than \$1.1 million.

Better Than Ready also finished among Australia's top 20 sires for a fourth successive season.

Queensland's Champion First Season Stallion Barbaric's first crop produced five winners of seven races from nine runners and \$232,165 in earnings.

The Group-winning son of I Am Invincible's (Invincible Spirit) cohort was

headed by The Barber, who won his only start of the season and earned \$96,100. Barbaric is out of stakes-winning mare Mimi Lebrock (Show A Heart).

Meanwhile, Eureka Stud's late Spirit Of Boom (Sequalo) was named Queensland Champion Two-Year-Old Stallion for the sixth time after another strong season with his juveniles.

The sire was represented by 12 individual two-year-old winners of 15 races from 40 runners, headed by Calaway Gal (Listed, 1200m) winner Boomelli, who won three of her six starts and earned \$240,100. His juvenile progeny earned \$1.45 million overall.

A dual Group 1 winner on the track, Spirit Of Boom developed into one of Queensland's most influential stallions, building a reputation for producing precocious and durable performers.

His sixth Champion Two-Year-Old Stallion title comes following his death earlier this year, with his final crops set to continue his influence on the Queensland breeding industry.

Sheza Gypsy was crowned Broodmare of the Year following the remarkable season of her daughter Sheza Alibi (Saxon Warrior), who established herself among Australia's best race mares. Bred in Queensland by Fred and Desley Monsour, Sheza Alibi earned almost \$3.72 million during the season.

since claiming the Black Caviar Lightning Stakes at Flemington almost 18 months ago. The Mitch Freedman-trained mare contested the Moir Stakes last year, finishing sixth behind Baraqiel (Snitzel) at Moonee Valley, but Freedman believes the switch to Sandown could suit the six-year-old. "Being at Sandown and not around The Valley, it changes the dynamics a bit," Freedman said. "Hopefully she can have a bit more luck than last year." A \$110,000 Inglis Classic purchase, Skybird was last seen finishing 13th in the Kingsford Smith Cup (Gr 1, 1300m) at Eagle Farm in May, having campaigned through Adelaide, Brisbane and Sydney. Skybird finished within a length of both Joliestar (Zoustar) and Giga Kick in the TJ Smith Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) in the autumn.

## Black Mountain ballot exemption added at Queanbeyan

A new ballot exemption for the \$50,000 TAB Federal Black Mountain Quality (1000m) at Canberra on September 18 will be offered to the first country-trained horse across the line in Tuesday week's Benchmark 74 Handicap (1000m) at Queanbeyan. The Black Mountain represents one of the final opportunities for country NSW and ACT-trained horses to press their claims for a slot in the \$2 million The Kosciuszko (1200m). Canberra Racing Club has also added a \$100,000 bonus for any horse able to break the Canberra 1000-metre track record in the Black Mountain. As a TAB Federal race, the Black Mountain is restricted to horses trained in country NSW and the ACT.

## Reminder to breeders on foal returns

Breeders are reminded that Live Foal Mare Returns and Foal Ownership Declarations (FODs) must be lodged within 30 days of a foal's birth. The Mare Return and FOD can now be completed as a single transaction through the Online Services section of the Australian Stud Book website by selecting 'Lodge Mare Return'. Failure to lodge the required information within 30 days of birth will make the horse ineligible for registration to race in Australia under Australian Rules of Racing AR285, AR286 and AR287. ## BOBS racehorse nominations close Tuesday

Nominations for the 2026 BOBS Racehorse Scheme, including BOBS Extra, will close on Tuesday, September 1. The current nomination period applies to horses foaled in 2024, which officially became two-year-olds on August 1, 2026. Owners wishing to nominate eligible horses must do so before Tuesday's deadline to avoid the substantially higher late nomination fee. Late nominations lodged after September 1, 2026 and before August 1, 2027 will attract a fee of \$5,500, including GST.

## Vale Bev Kelso

New Zealand racing is in mourning following the death of respected Matamata trainer Bev Kelso, aged 80, who passed away on Saturday following a period of illness. Kelso trained in partnership with husband Ken, the pair associated with a succession of outstanding mares, most recently multiple Group 1 winners Legarto (Proisir) and Levante (Proisir), as well as current sprint star Alabama Lass (Alabama Express). The Kelsos had trained together since 1978, and Legarto provided a special moment for the family in Bev's final days when the recently retired mare was named Matamata Horse of the Year at the region's annual awards on Thursday night. Alabama Lass will continue the stable's legacy when she takes her place in Saturday's \$400,000 Proisir Plate (Gr 1, 1400m) at Ellerslie. The mare heads to the feature after an impressive first-up victory in the Foxbridge Plate (Gr 2, 1200m). A celebration of Bev Kelso's life will be held at Matamata Racecourse on September 14.

## HK: Ka Ying Rising cruises in Sha Tin trial

World's highest-rated sprinter Ka Ying Rising (Shamexpress) continued his preparation for his seasonal return with a comfortable trial victory at Sha Tin on Sunday. Ridden by

regular jockey Zac Purton, the David Hayes-trained gelding cruised through the 1000-metre turf trial in 56.73 seconds on a Good surface, defeating Public Attention (Written Tycoon) by two lengths, with Magic Control (Sioux Nation) in third. Ka Ying Rising will resume in the HK\$4.2 million HKSAR Chief Executive's Cup Handicap (Gr 3, 1200m) at Sha Tin on September 6, bidding for a third consecutive victory in the race and to extend his remarkable winning sequence to 21. "He jumped out well, he cruised along. He just did enough to tick him over for his race next week," Purton said. "He's a bit fitter now, he moved a bit better, his action was a bit better." The reigning joint Hong Kong Horse of the Year will enter two weeks of quarantine immediately following his first-up run before travelling to Sydney, where he will attempt to defend his title in the \$20 million The Everest (Gr 1, 1200m) at Randwick on October 17.

## JPN: Second stakes win for Maurice colt

Arrowfield Stud shuttler Maurice (Screen Hero) was represented by another Japanese stakes winner on Sunday when three-year-old colt Zoroastro claimed the Niigata Kinen (Gr 3, 2000m). Ridden by Mirai Iwata, Zoroastro prevailed in extremely heavy rain to register the second Group 3 success of his career, the colt having previously won February's Kisaragi Sho (Gr 3, 1800m). Bred by Northern Farm, Zoroastro is the second foal out of the Deep Impact (Sunday Silence) mare Almirena, adding another stakes performer bred on the increasingly successful Maurice-Deep Impact cross.

**International****16 for Gun Runner**

A day after Gun Runner's (Candy Ride) only Australian starter Genesis Runner was stakes placed in the Up and Coming Stakes (Gr 3, 1300m), undefeated colt Leading Change became the fourth Grade 1 winner for the Three Chimneys Farm sire this year, and sixteenth overall, with victory in Saturday's US\$1.25 million Travers Stakes (Gr 1, 10f) at Saratoga. The Brad Cox-trained three-year-old was having just his third start, having missed his juvenile season to bone bruising before debuting on June 7 and subsequently winning the Indiana Derby (Gr 3, 9f). Ridden by Manny Franco, Leading Change settled third along the rail before moving into the clear in the straight and wearing down Preakness Stakes (Gr 1, 9.5f) winner Napoleon Solo (Liam's Map) late to score by half a length. Kentucky Derby (Gr 1, 10f) and Belmont Stakes (Gr 1, 10f) winner Golden Tempo (Curlin) finished another two-and-a-quarter lengths away in third. Bred by WinStar Farm, Leading Change was purchased by Wathnan Racing for US\$800,000 from the Taylor Made Sales Agency draft at the 2024 Keeneland September Yearling Sale. He is the tenth foal and third stakes winner out of the Congrats

(A.P. Indy) mare Starship Warspeed and is a half-brother to Kentucky Oaks (Gr 1, 9f) winner Shedaresthedevil (Daredevil). Gun Runner has sired 61 individual stakes winners at 11.5 per cent and over 71 per cent winners to runners.

**Grade 1 breakthrough for In Our Time**

In Our Time (Not This Time) secured her first Grade 1 victory with a dominant front-running performance in Saturday's US\$1.67 million Kentucky Downs Ladies Turf Sprint Stakes (Gr 1, 6.5f). The five-year-old mare led before drawing clear in the straight to defeat Time To Dazzle (Not This Time) by three-and-a-half lengths in 1:16.01 on firm turf. The victory continued a strong season for In Our Time, who had previously landed the Giant's Causeway Stakes (Gr 2, 5.5f) at Keeneland and was placed in last year's Matriarch Stakes (Gr 1, 8f) at Del Mar. She has now won six of her 20 starts, with six seconds and three thirds, earning US\$1.99 million for Resolute Racing and Miller Racing. Bred in Kentucky by Brian Kahn, In Our Time is out of the Cactus Ridge (Hennessy) mare Laura's Pleasure and became another elite-level performer for leading North American sire Not This Time (Giant's Causeway). The Taylor Made Stallions resident, who stood for US\$250,000

(approx. AU\$349,025) in 2026, currently heads the North American general sires' table.

**76 for Showcasing**

Wathnan Racing-owned juvenile filly Light Of Dawn (2 f ex An Ghalanta, by Holy Roman Emperor) provided Whitsbury Manor Stud sire Showcasing (Oasis Dream) with his 76th individual stakes winner when landing Sunday's Prestige Fillies' Stakes (Gr 3, 7f) at Goodwood. Trained by Karl Burke, the filly came through under James Doyle to lead before the furlong marker, avoiding any trouble in what turned out to be a tight finish for the minor placings. She stuck to the task to defeat Ebha (Space Blues) by a length and a quarter, while Coaxed (Baaeed) was another half-length back in third. Bred by The An Ghalanta Partnership, Light Of Dawn was a 140,000gns buy for Longways Stables at Book 1 of the Tattersalls October Yearling Sale before making €625,000 to the bid of Blandford Bloodstock at the Arqana May Breeze-Up Sale this year. Also stakes-placed in the Albany Stakes (Gr 3, 6f) at Royal Ascot in June, she is one of four black type performers out of An Ghalanta, following Listed scorers Time Scale (Charm Spirit) and Miaharris (Zoustar) as well as the Group 2-placed Bletchley (Makfi). Showcasing stood the 2026 season for £30,000 (approx. AU\$56,670).

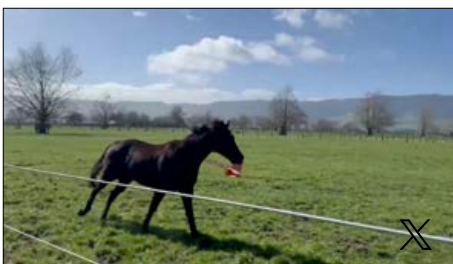

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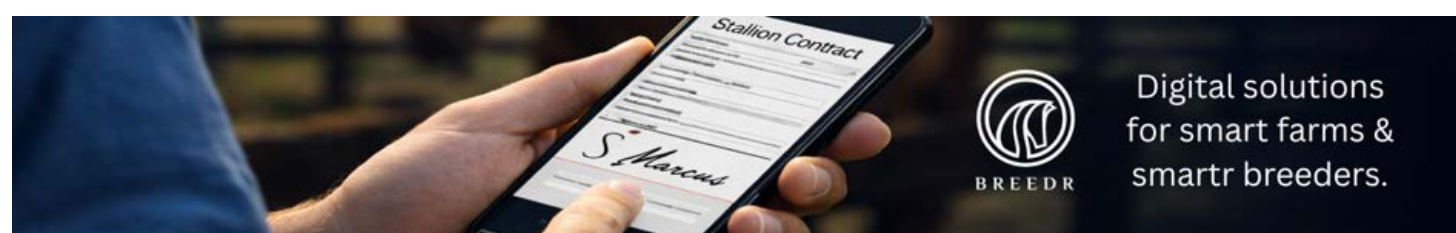
