Ryan colt aiming to Standout in Expressway

Listed-winning son of Exceed And Excel out to bolster fine record of three-year-old sprinters this season

orumbene Stud home-bred Standout (Exceed And Excel) will try to become the fourth three-year-old to defy the older horses in a major all-comers sprint this season when he lines-up in today's Expressway Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) at Randwick.

Gerald Ryan has been guarded in his assessment of the Exceed And Excel (Danehill) colt's prospects in the lead-up to the race, but there is much to support the argument, at least speculatively at the odds available (currently \$5.50 with the TAB), that he could get the better of his ostensibly more fancied older rivals.

The three-year-old sprinting competitiveness, if not superiority, was established early in the season when Dalasan (Dalakhani) - who resumes in today's Manfred Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) at Caulfield - defeated subsequent Group 1 winner Scales Of Justice (Not A Single Doubt) in August's Spring Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m), run almost two months shy of his third birthday.

<< Continued from page 1 Of course, the trend continued with Yes Yes Yes (Rubick) winning the \$14 million The Everest (1200m) before Loving Gaby (I Am Invincible) claimed the Manikato Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) six days later.

The case for three-year-olds in the Expressway is also stronger than a cursory look might reveal.

Ryan himself won the race in 2018 with then three-year-old Trapeze Artist (Snitzel), who became the first of the Classic generation to land the contest since Happy Galaxy (Nadeem) in 2013. However, only two more three-year-olds have contested the race in the subsequent seven years.

Later in that autumn campaign, Trapeze Artist reverted to sprinting and won the TJ Smith Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) and All-Aged Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) having been tried over a mile in the Randwick Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m), running third of 14 against his own age group.

Ryan believes Standout is a 'good horse' but has spoken of his inexperience, with the colt having made only four starts for three wins.

However, 1998 winner Hockney (Quest For Fame) was just a five-time starter when landing the spoils at three, while Mentality (Flying Spur) and the champion Saintly (Sky Chase) complete the list of three-year-old winners in the past 30 years.

Standout has trialled well in preparation for his return having last been seen finishing second to Cosmic Force (Deep Field) in the Roman Consul Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m), run over the same course and distance on October 12.

"It is just a question of whether he's up to weight-for-age level at only fifth start in a race," Ryan said.

"He's trialled well and come through the two trials really well. I'm hopeful he'll be up to it."

Standout faces nine rivals this afternoon, three of whom were late entries when the nominations were extended. The eleventh-hour participants are second-favourite Kolding (Ocean Park), Kiamichi (Sidestep) and Vegadaze (Lope De Vega).

The Expressway winner was first-up in five years straight before last year's heroine Alizee (Sepoy), who returns to defend her crown today, won the Christmas Classic (Listed, 1200m) prior to taking out the Randwick feature.

This year's Christmas Classic runner-up, Glenall (Redoute's Choice), is prepared by Team Hawkes, who have won this race five times (three in John's name only). The Bjorn Baker-trained Irithea (Snitzel) is the only

other a starter with a recent run behind her, finishing second at the Gold coast last month.

James Cummings, who is doubly-represented courtesy of Alizee and Kiamichi, expects last year's winner to be highly competitive again, although he told Sky Sports Radio that Standout and Kolding were the dangers.

<< Continued from page 2 "She's always fresh and she'll be bouncing out of her skin," Cummings said of Alizee.</p>

"And she'll be very competitive against those horses, but I have a healthy respect for George Altamonte's three-year-old (Standout) and Kolding.

"I'm full of admiration for what he did last spring. Since he's been gelded he's been close enough to unbeatable. If they line up she'll have a good fight on her hands, but she'll be right in it."

Cummings said Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Kiamichi may be reserved for next Saturday's Eskimo Prince Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) given her liking for soft ground and the unsettled forecast.

Rain and wild weather is predicted to hit Caulfield today where Dalasan resumes his spring rivalries with the Anthony Freedman-trained duo of Super Seth (Dundeel) and Groundswell (Fastnet Rock) in the Manfred Stakes, while the Team Hawkes-trained Spend (Snitzel), who made a successful debut at Rosehill in July, adds another dimension to the race.

Leon Macdonald believes Dalasan is ready to maintain his unbeaten record fresh, while Anthony Freedman's assistant trainer and son, Sam, suggests Groundswell might have a slight edge on his Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m)-winning stablemate Super Seth.

"He's undefeated first-up," Macdonald said of Dalasan.

"He did beat Scales Of Justice in the Spring Stakes, so I suppose that makes the form stack up a bit, doesn't it?

"He's in good order and has done everything asked of him and I'm confident he'll run well."

Sam Freedman said of his duo: "They've come back really well. Obviously they're both first-up off two nice trials.

"With Groundswell, we're on a different tack. We've taken the blinkers off and we will ride him quiet. We think we might see a really good turn of foot from him."

Regarding Super Seth, Freedman added: "We'll probably ride him quiet as well, but in the small field he won't be too far off them and then the last furlong he'll be strong.

"I'd be surprised if he's not the fastest in the field late, but I'd lean to Groundswell just as at the 1200 (metres) he might have a little bit more zip."

The Caulfield card also features the Chairman's Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) for two-year-olds.

The Caulfield-trained trio of Extreme Choice (Not A Single Doubt)

(2016), Road To Success (Dolphin Street) (2000) and Redoute's Choice (Danehill) (1999) are the only three horses to have landed the Group 3 prior to taking out the Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m).

Ideas Man (Brazen Beau) and Rock Of Kryptonite (Fastnet Rock) are the two Caulfield-trained colts in this year's edition and both have generated plenty of media attention in the lead-up to today's race.

Ciaron Maher, who trains in partnership with David Eustace, spoke enthusiastically of Ideas Man, who made a winning debut when taking out the Inglis Banner (RL, 1000m) at Moonee Valley in October.

"He had a nice break and he's trialled up well. I think he has improved," Maher said.

"He's come on as a racehorse, he's a bit sharper. He's drawn well (3) to get a nice run, right on speed, and he'll be hard to beat."

Michael Kent jnr, who trains in partnership with Mick Price, was similarly upbeat about Rock Of Kryptonite, who was on edge in the preliminaries prior to running seventh of nine first-up in the Debutant Stakes (Listed, 1000m) at Caulfield.

"He's had two jumpouts and won both. I think a lot of him. Ideas Man looks hard to beat but this is a good horse," Kent jnr said.

"He's by Fastnet Rock and it would be fantastic to win this race and get into the Blue Diamond."

Kent said both Damien Oliver and Ben Melham had worked the horse. While both jockeys were keen to ride the colt today, Price gave Melham the nod earlier in the week.

First for Press Statement

Vinery Stud resident Press Statement (Hinchinbrook) sired his first winner yesterday when Spokesman (2 c ex Calaluna by Mujahid) broke his maiden second-up over 1250 metres at Canterbury. The Chris Waller-trained juvenile, who ran third at the track on January 17, improved on that effort to pull half a length clear of Thermosphere (Exosphere), with a further short-head back to Setanta (Fastnet Rock) in third. A \$270,000 Inglis Classic Yearling Sale purchase last year, being knocked down to Star Thoroughbreds and Randwick Bloodstock (FBAA) from the draft of Fairview Park Stud, Spokesman is from the family of Victory Vein (Mr Henrysee), who was crowned Australia's champion two-year-old filly in 2001-02. Press Statement covered 161 mares at a fee of \$16,500 (inc GST) last year, while Fairview are set to offer a Your Song (Fastnet Rock) half-sister to Spokesman at this year's edition of the Inglis Classic Yearling Sale. She is catalogued as Lot 36.

AQUIS FAR

The Peter Fleming-trained Java Sparrow (2 f ex Sintessa by Snippets) produced an imperious performance to win by five lengths on debut at Bowen yesterday and in doing so handed late Aquis Farm shuttler Spill The Beans (Snitzel) his fourth individual juvenile winner. In Memory Ofa Mate (Golden Archer) ran second, while Latina Rocket (Canford Cliffs) was a further two and a quarter lengths back in third. Spill The Beans covered 116 mares at a fee of \$11,000 (inc GST) last year prior to dying suddenly in November. Unbeaten as a two-year-old, he won the Hawkesbury Guineas (Gr 3, 1400m) and QTC Cup (Gr 2, 1300m) at three, while he

shuttled to the National Stud in Newmarket for one northern hemisphere breeding season in 2018. Spill The Beans has one youngster catalogued at the Inglis Classic Yearling Sale. She is Lot 741.

Small field should suit Benjamin

Assistant trainer Sam Freedman believes European import Just Benjamin (Epaulette), who suffered a luckless run when finishing fifth on his Australian debut at Caulfield, will be well suited by the small field when returning to the track in today's Mal Seccull Handicap (1800m). The son of Epaulette (Commands) hit a flat spot on his first start for Anthony Freedman before picking up well, which caught Damien Oliver, who retains the ride today, by surprise. "Ollie didn't think he would take off like he did and then he was running into dead-ends," Sam Freedman said. "It was one to forget, for sure, but in this small field if he hits that flat spot, he should come out of it fine and hopefully keep surging to the line." Just Benjamin will face will face seven rivals today, including Mike Moroney's promising import Aktau (Teofilo),



and Freedman added: "We're still learning about our horse. He's not a flash track worker, but he had a nice trial last Friday and seems as well as he did before his first-up run. He'll appreciate getting out to this trip."

Firm track ideal for Godolphin filly

Jason Collett, who rode Godolphin-raced filly In Flanders (Exceed And Excel) to finish behind high-class runner-up Cellsabeel (Hinchinbrook) at Rosehill on January 18, believes the juvenile will be better suited by a firm track at Randwick today. Fifth in the Gimcrack Stakes (Gr 3, 1000m) on soft ground first-up, In Flanders raced on a heavy track at Rosehill last start, but Collett believes good ground for today's Widden Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) will be much more to her liking. "She got through it (wet) OK, but I think she will be better on top of the ground," Collett said. "She tried very hard in it, but I don't know that she was completely at home in it." In Flanders dug deep to reel in her James Cummings-trained stable companion Beyliks (Lonhro) at Rosehill and Collett added: "The stablemate was probably stopping a bit, but I said to James that I did like that she got up for second. She had to be tough to do that because she wasn't at home on the track. I'll get a better idea tomorrow where she's at. She's got quite a bit of brilliance but she just needs harnessing."

Our Mantra steps up in grade

Our Mantra (Sebring) will contest the Osim Open Handicap (1840m) at Eagle Farm today, with trainer Robert Heathcote having decided to bypass the Class 6 Plate (1600m), run earlier on the card, following the barrier draw. "He had 59 kilograms and barrier ten in the Class 6 and barrier three and 54 (kilograms) in the open," Heathcote said. "He is second-up and

1600 metres is probably more suitable, but he has a few things in his favour." Promising stayer Our Mantra, who was originally trained by Joe Pride in Sydney, has won four races since joining Heathcote last year. He will once again be ridden by Robbie Fradd.

Rain expected at Caulfield

Heavy rainfall is expected during today's meeting at Caulfield. While the track was rated within the good range yesterday, between 10 and 30 millimetres of rain is forecast for today, with the temperature dropping to 29 degrees from a high of over 40. Conditions are expected to suit local trainer Clinton McDonald's three-pronged assault on the meeting, with his Diamond Effort (Mossman), Causeway Girl (Shamus Award) and Never Again (High Chaparral) all having won on soft ground previously. "She was terrific her first couple of runs last prep and then we ran into a couple of issues, so we gave her a good spell," McDonald told Racing.com of Diamond Effort. "She's had two jump-outs leading into this and we've been really happy with her and we're expecting a forward showing." Of Causeway Girl, he added: "Her work here on Tuesday on the course proper was probably the best work she has ever done. I've spaced her runs, she's fit and now she's coping with racing. Once those mares get in form they usually hold it and that's where she's at I think."

Oakleigh Plate on the agenda for Humma Humma

Dual Listed winner Humma Humma (Denman), who will make her first start this preparation in the W J Adams Stakes (Listed, 1000m) at Caulfield today, is being set for a tilt at the Oakleigh Plate (Gr 1, 1100m) back at the track on February 22. Trainer John McArdle also has the four-year-old entered in the Newmarket Handicap (Gr 1, 1200m) at

Flemington on March 7, but he said: "She was put in the Newmarket just in case, but she's not much good at Flemington. So it will be this race and then hopefully to the Oakleigh Plate and after that we're open to Sydney, Brisbane, Adelaide. We'll let her tell us." While Humma Humma is yet to race beyond 1200 metres in her 18 starts, McArdle is open to stretching her out in distance. "We'll see what she does during the campaign," he added. "She may step out and have a go at something like the Stradbroke, but that will depend purely with what happens as we go along. There's a lot of different options for her, but that will be worked out race by race."

Resuming Runson has Rubiton target

The Leon and Troy Corstens-trained Runson (Delzao) is likely to begin his autumn campaign in the Rubiton Stakes (Gr 2, 1100m) after pleasing connections in a jump-out at Flemington yesterday morning. The seven-year-old had legitimate excuses for his below-par runs in the spring and is being set to return next Saturday following his second trial yesterday. "He is really good," Troy Corstens told Racing.com. "We just had a few little lung issues - he had a virus last preparation and it showed in his form. He is usually extremely consistent and there was just a couple of runs there that he didn't perform to where we know he is at. We ran a course of penicillin through him. Now we didn't take him out of work, I just sent him down to the beach and he did extremely well down there." Corstens continued: "His two trials back have been excellent. We are likely to kick him off in the Rubiton next week - I think the 1100 metres at Caulfield will suit him. Mark Zahra has ridden in both of his trials and we are just seeing if he can ride him at the moment."

Xilong impresses in Gawler trial

The Tony and Calvin McEvoy-trained Xilong (Deep Field) put down a significant marker for the future when recording the fastest trial of the day at Gawler yesterday. A four-time winner who took out the Twilight Glow Stakes (Listed, 1400m) when last sighted in November, Xilong finished her 1000-metre hit-out in 1.01.20 under Todd Parnell. "We know she's a filly with a lot of class. If she comes through this trial in good order, the intention is to send her to Sydney for the \$1 million Inglis Sprint for three year-olds at Warwick Farm next Saturday," Calvin McEvoy told Racing.com.

Yes Yes Yes set for Randwick gallop

Group 1-winning stablemates Yes Yes Yes (Rubick) and Kings Will Dream (Casamento) will add further star power to the Expressway Stakes meeting when they gallop together between races at Randwick. Glen Boss will be reunited with the Chris Waller-trained Everest (1200m) winner Yes Yes Yes after Nash Rawiller warmed the saddle in a recent barrier trial while Boss was on holiday. The Waller-trained Night's Watch (Redwood), Shared Ambition (Born To Sea) and Youngstar (High Chaparral) will also work after race two.

RV add extra races

Five races have been added to up-coming race programmes across Victoria after last night's meeting at Moonee Valley was called off because of excessive heat. Next Thursday's Pakenham night meeting will now be a tenrace card instead of eight, while the following night's Moonee Valley programme will feature two additional races, making it a ten-race fixture. A 1400-metre Benchmark 70 and 1600-metre Benchmark 70 have been added to the Pakenham programme, while a 3000-metre Benchmark 64 and 2040-metre Benchmark 70 have been added to The Valley meeting. A maiden for two-year-olds has been added to the programme at Bendigo on February 15.

Gold Coast carnival dates announced

Magic Millions yesterday announced the dates for the next four years of the Gold Coast carnival.

Next year, inspections commence on January 8, the Book 1 and 2 sales take place from January 13 to 17 inclusive and Magic Millions raceday will be staged on January 16. In 2022, inspections commence on January 7, Book 1 and 2 sales take place from January 12 to 16 inclusive and Magic Millions raceday will be staged on January 15. The 2023 dates are inspections from January 6, Book 1 and 2 sales from January 11 to 15 inclusive and Magic Millions raceday on January 14. In 2024, inspections commence on January 5, Book 1 and 2 sales take place from January 10 to 14 inclusive and Magic Millions raceday will be staged on January 13.

NEW ZEALAND

Thursday trial for Melody Belle

Leading All-Star Mile (1600m) hopeful Melody Belle (Commands) will feature in a special trial before racing at Tauranga on Thursday. The equalfavourite for March's \$5 million contest at Caulfield was scheduled to trial at Taupo on Tuesday, but a lack of rain in the area has forced stewards to cancel the trials. Instead, the ten-time Group 1 winner will head to Tauranga on Thursday to gallop in a specially arranged trial for Group and Listed class horses over 1050 metres. "The trials were set for a place called Taupo but there's no water there and the track would have been like a road," her trainer Jamie Richards told Racing.com. "We've got permission to have that trial before the first race on Thursday and so that keeps her pretty much on the same programme we'd set out for her. She then flies over - I think she's on the same flight as Catalyst - next Sunday, the ninth. She'll kick off her campaign in the Futurity."

Wrote reception pleases Gillovic

Highview Stud's Brent Gillovic is delighted with the reception first season sire Wrote (High Chaparral) received at Karaka this week. After the Group 1 winner's sole representative in Book 1 sold for \$50,000, his six yearlings in the Book 2 session of New Zealand Bloodstock's National Yearling Sale averaged \$62,000, with two fillies selling for \$80,000 each. "They have sold fantastically through Book 2 and we just sold a filly in Book 3 for \$24,000, so it's great," Gillovic said. "Everybody

has fallen in love with them a bit. Those who got them were determined to get them. The mares he got in his first year were relying on us and the mares were probably not great quality, so to get these prices is unreal. The two \$80,000 fillies, I think we spent \$500 to buy one of their dams and we got the other one for nothing. So they are not had results"

Richards expecting bold show from Prise De Fer

Jamie Richards believes Prise De Fer (Savabeel) can keep his winning run going when the fouryear-old contests today's Taranaki Cup (Gr 3, 1800m). Prise De Fer has hit a purple patch of form this season and heads into today's race aiming for his fifth successive win following victory in the Rich Hill Mile (Gr 2, 1600m) at Ellerslie on New Year's Day. "He was given a lovely ride three-deep with a bit of cover in the Rich Hill Mile, he had a nice light weight and I thought he did it pretty impressively," Richards said. "We are happy with him. He has had a bit of time between runs, which he seems to enjoy. He went up to Ellerslie and worked with Probabeel and he worked nicely. He jumps up a little bit in weight with the set-weights and penalties conditions of the race, but I thought it suited him better than going to the Herbie Dyke at weight-for-age. He has drawn a bit awkwardly (11), but we think he is going well and he is going to be very competitive."

Who Dares Wins out to add to tally

Who Dares Wins (Iffraaj) will attempt to add to his tally of three stakes wins when he lines up in the White Robe Lodge WFA (Gr 3, 1600m) at Wingatui today. The seven-year-old bounced back to winning ways when taking out the Timaru Cup (Listed, 1600m) last start, a performance which delighted connections. "We were rapt with his win at Timaru," said co-trainer Lyn Prendergast. "She (Samantha Wynne, jockey) had to turn him pretty sharp to get a run and I couldn't be happier. We gave him a week off after the Timaru Cup. He gets quite gross and puts on a lot of weight, so we gave him a little trial. We were really happy with his trial, we didn't want to give him a hard trial. He is as ready as we can get him, he is bang on."

Auckland Cup aim for Sound

Michael Moroney is planning a trip across the Tasman to target the Auckland Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) at Ellerslie on March 7 with Sound (Lando). The seven-year-old finished fifth fresh-up over 2000 metres at Caulfield last Saturday, an effort which pleased the trainer. "I thought he went really well on Saturday," Moroney said. "He got a gorgeous trip and was really well ridden. He loomed to win at the right time but then he got on tired legs a bit first-up. We thought we had him forward enough, but he is a stallion and he is a gross type of horse. The lack of match practice just found him out."



Derby aspirants vie for position at Sha Tin

The picture for the Hong Kong Derby (Listed, 2000m) should become a little clearer tomorrow when six Derby entrants will attempt to strengthen their credentials in the Class 2 Azalea Handicap (1800m) at Sha Tin. New Zealand import Super Oasis (Exceed And Excel), who will be ridden by Joao Moreira, is among the mix of hopefuls, along with Enjoying (Dundeel), Columbus County (Redwood), Butterfield (Setembro Chove), Savvy Nine (Anodin) and Amazing Beats (Epaulette. Moreira, who rode Columbus County last time out, has narrowed his shortlist down to three leading candidates. "I don't think there's much between Enjoying, Super Oasis and Columbus County," he said. "It seems like these three are the stand-outs and this race will give us a very good guide toward the Hong Kong Derby."

INTERNATIONAL

181 for Dubawi

A breakthrough win from Secret Advisor (6 g ex Sub Rose by Galileo) in Thursday's Meydan Cup (Listed, 2800m) provided Darley's super sire Dubawi (Dubai Millennium) with his 181st individual stakes winner. The lightly-raced, Charlie Appleby-trained six-year-old beat Dubai Horizon (Poet's Voice) by a length on what was just his third start in two and a half years, with Dubhe (Dubawi) another

three-quarters of a length away in third. Secret Advisor has now won three of his nine starts with a further three placings.

Barney back with a bang

Barney Roy (Excelebration) took a successful first step en route to the Dubai Turf (Gr 1, 1800m) on World Cup night when the six-year-old won the Al Rashidiya (Gr 2, 1800m) at Meydan on Thursday. The Charlie Appleby-trained six-yearold, who was having his first start since finishing down the field at Royal Ascot last June, ran on well under William Buick for a comfortable two and a quarter-length success from Dream Castle (Frankel), with another six and a quarter lengths back to Mountain Hunter (Lonhro) in third. Barney Roy, who returned to training last year following an unsuccessful spell at stud, has now won five of his 11 starts and four in stakes company, with his most notable victory coming in the St James's Palace Stakes (Gr 1, 1m) in 2017.

King rules again

Gladiator King (Curlin) made it two wins from two starts since joining Satish Seemar when the ex-American sprinter took out the Al Shindagha Sprint (Gr 3, 1200m) on the Meydan dirt on Thursday. The four-year-old was following up his recent win over the track and trip when he came home a length in front of Truck Salesman (Can The Man) who in turn was a length and a quarter in front of Ibn Malik (Raven's Pass). Gladiator King now boasts three stakes successes in his tally of four wins from 11 starts.

Memphis heading to Australia

Agent Matthew Houldsworth is hoping history can repeat itself after he went to 62,000gns (\$127,500) for Memphis (Dubawi), an unraced half-sister to Lyric Of Light (Street Cry), from this year's Godolphin offering at the opening session

of the Tattersalls February Sale in Newmarket on Thursday. It was during the 2017 February Sale that Houldsworth purchased Dream In Colour (Frankel) for 75,000gns (\$154,000) from the Godolphin draft. His clients reaped rich dividends when she went on to produce an Exceed And Excel (Danehill) colt who sold to Coolmore for \$1.1 million during the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale. "She's been bought to go to Australia as a breeding proposition for a new client," said Houldsworth. "She's a typical Dubawi and a half-sister to a Group 1 winner who is now breeding well. It goes back to a good family too." Lyric Of Light has bred three winners and also has a yearling filly by Shamardal (Giant's Causeway) on the ground.

Moore booked for Rainbow ride in Sun Met

Ryan Moore will ride at Kenilworth for the first time today where he takes the mount on board last year's winner Rainbow Bridge (Ideal World) in the Sun Met (Gr 1, 2000m). Moore has a total of four rides on the 12-race card and Rainbow Bridge's trainer Eric Sands is understandably delighted to have secured his services. "How good is it for South African racing that we can attract a man of Ryan's calibre," he said. "Assuming they sort out the export protocols as planned we could have Aidan O'Brien deciding he wants to send horses here for the Met in two or three years' time - and who is going to tell him what a great place this is?" Rainbow Bridge is third-favourite locally at 4-1 with Queen's Plate (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Vardy (Var) and the Mike de Kock-trained Hawwaam (Silvano) jointly heading the market at 28-10.

Sudden death of French agent Le Forban

French bloodstock agent Sebastien Le Forban died suddenly in Florida on Wednesday evening. He was 35. The grandson of a trainer and son of a former amateur rider, Le Forban was bred into racing and established his agency ITS Bloodstock in 2013. He had previously worked in Australia and then in Dubai for trainer Satish Seemar. Le Forban made a splash at last year's Arqana Arc Sale, purchasing the Group 1-placed Graignes (Zoffany) and the Listed-winning filly Les Hogues (Bated Breath) for the same English clients for a combined €780,000 (\$1.3million).


