Harron lands sought after Crabtree-bred son of champion Victorian stallion

One of Australia's most respected and highest-profile yearling buyers has helped the Inglis Melbourne Premier achieve a seven-figure milestone for just the second time in the sale's history after a colt by remarkable

stallion Written Tycoon (Iglesia) sold during a record day's trade.

James Harron, with a good deal of confidence, alluded to the fact his prominent syndicate would be active on the colt by delaying a media interview until after the star attraction went through the Oaklands Junction ring about two hours into the opening session.

And he came true on his promise, securing the colt over Coolmore, when the price moved from \$1.05 million to the \$1.1 million.

The market was expected to follow on from the other record Australian yearling sales held so far this year and, despite a tempered start to proceedings, the action heated up in the early afternoon as a series of high-calibre yearlings were sold, highlighted by the \$1.1 million Harron-purchased colt from the draft of leading vendor Blue Gum Farm.

"He is a top-quality colt, bred by one of the best breeders here in Victoria in Rob Crabtree. He is a very, very nice colt and he handled the sale nicely," Harron said.

"His mother Gybe was very good. I remember her racing and winning

a Gimcrack and she was very talented and this guy is by Written Tycoon who is doing an amazing job.

"Now with Capitalist at stud, he looks like being a real sire of sires."

The model employed by Harron

and his partners is to buy colts who have the pedigree and credentials to go on and become stallions as Capitalist and Pariah (Redoute's Choice) have already done and King's Legacy (Redoute's Choice) will do this season.

"He is a horse who ticks a lot of the boxes for stallions going forward. He has to do it on the track, obviously, but he is a beautiful individual," he said.

"He was a very late October foal, so there's still a bit of development and improving to do. He is a very classy colt and he would have stacked up very well at any sale this year in my opinion and I'm glad to get him."

Harron added: "I thought he was a million dollar horse from what we've seen so far this year. I thought he was going to command a lot of attention.

"It is very difficult to breed that kind of horse."

The fourth million dollar lot ever sold by Written Tycoon, and the second most expensive colt, he is the fourth living foal out of Gybe (Fastnet Rock), an ATC Gimcrack Stakes (Listed, 1000m) winner. Catalogued as Lot 70, he was offered by Blue Gum Farm on behalf of Dorrington Farm.

The million-dollar milestone moment was not lost on Blue Gum's Philip Campbell with the colt becoming the farm's first seven-figure yearling in 40 years of selling horses.

Fittingly, the retiring Simon Vivian was on the podium conducting the auction when the seven-figure colt was sold.

“Simon Vivian and I wanted to take the horse to Melbourne Premier, because we honestly believed we would be able to achieve a result not dissimilar to what he has,” Campbell said.

“First of all, I am rapt for Rob and Sylvie (Crabtree), as well as Fiona, who is back at Dorrington, she has done a wonderful job.

“To the guys at our farm who have prepped the horse, it’s just amazing, I can’t wait to get back down there and celebrate. It is a real team effort and we are so lucky at our farm that we have such wonderful clients.

“Last year, we topped the sale for Neville and Susan Duncan, and this year, to be topping it so far for Rob and Sylvie is a big thrill.

“It’s a dream result, which hasn’t quite sunk in.”

Campbell, whose operation sold 13 yearlings yesterday for \$3.04 million, revealed the colt had impressed all the major top-end colts buyers during numerous inspections and the horse handled the sales experience with aplomb.

“For me, these people have got to see yearlings come out of the box and fill their eye,” he said.

“That’s what this bloke did, and not just for one person, he filled the eye of many. He had the physical prowess, he has got the page, he was by the right stallion at the right time and he was just the perfect storm.”

The colt will head to Kolara Lodge in Queensland to be broken in before returning to Melbourne to be trained by Anthony and Sam Freedman.

The most expensive yearling sold at the Premier sale was an I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit) colt, later named Octane, who made \$1.4 million at the 2017 sale.

Harron lands another Capitalist colt

You can never have too much of a good thing and that was Harron’s rationale in buying another second crop colt by the Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Capitalist (Written Tycoon) who, of course, carried his colours to a stellar two-year-old career.

So far this year, Harron has bought five yearlings by Capitalist, one at the Magic Millions Gold Coast sale, three at the Inglis Classic and yesterday’s colt from Premier for \$340,000 from Northmore Thoroughbreds.

He was sold not long before Harron launched at the session-topping \$1.1 million colt.

“We have got a few Capitalists and he is obviously doing an incredible job at stud and I think everybody’s quite excited about him,” Harron said.

“He’s got some of the best colts in the country competing against the whole stallion pool.

“This colt was very forward, very strong and he had a really good mind on him.”

Catalogued as Lot 63, he is the third foal out of Grand Gesture (Starspangledbanner), a half-sister to Cool ‘N’ Sassy (Testa Rossa), herself the dam of New Zealand’s champion two-year-old of 2019-20, Cool Aza Beel (Savabeel).

The Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) and Karaka Million (RL, 1200m) winner will stand his first season at Newhaven Park later this year.

Earlier, a Capitalist filly held the honour as the session’s top lot for less than an hour when Caulfield trainer Clinton McDonald combined with client Domenic Romanelli to land the daughter of Flying Siren (Flying Spur) for \$300,000.

Capitalist has taken all before him with his first crop two-year-olds, but McDonald did not come to the Premier sale to specifically target one of his progeny.

“She was just one who stood out to us. We come here with an open book. We look at every horse in the catalogue and we just try to find racehorses. I think this sale is a very good one to buy racehorses from and one we’ve had great success out of,” McDonald said.

“We bought Weekend Hussler here for \$80,000 and Diamond Effort for \$130,000, so it is a sale where you can buy a good horse for not a lot of money and get involved.”

Offered by Milburn Creek as Lot 38, the filly is the second foal out of Flying Siren, a half-sister to Group 2 winner Catapulted (Catbird).

“We have a certain type that we like to buy, Domenic and myself, and he did all the pedigrees and it matched up really well. She was a high rating on pedigree and I just liked her as a type,” the trainer said.

“She’s an athletic filly with a good walk, a good hindquarter and let’s hope she can run.”

Despite the urge to chase a quick return with their new filly, McDonald revealed there will be no rush to push her if she showed she was not ready to race early in the new season.

“Dom is not one to push them. If she’s there and she’s got the ability, she will be there, but if she needs time, we’ll give her the time and that’s the best thing about training for Dom,” he said.

“He’s a very patient man and he loves to give his horses time and that is why he has them racing as four, five and six-year-olds.”

McDonald bought six yearlings on day one for a total spend of \$815,000.

McArdle digs deep for filly from favourite Mumma family

There was short odds available that John McArdle would buy the Zoustar (Northern Meteor) filly soon after she was born but it became no betting after her siblings, two-year-old Tycoon Humma (Capitalist), won the Festival Stakes (Listed, 1000m) and another half-sister Humma Humma (Denman) was stakes-placed at Flemington on Saturday.

McArdle already trains four foals out of Humma Mumma (Bel Esprit) and was not going home without the Flinders Park-consigned filly even if she came with a significant price increase at \$600,000.

"It is good to get a stakes winner but it's obviously cost me a bit more money today, so lucky we got the prize-money yesterday to help pay for her," said McArdle, who signed for the filly under his Redgum Racing banner.

"I have seen her as a foal, I have seen her on the farm and I have seen her a fair few times here, so it was probably the worst-kept secret in the world that I was going to buy her.

"We were more than happy to secure her being by a champion stallion and obviously from a very good family."

Offered as Lot 87, she is the sixth foal out of Humma Mumma who is proving to be a grand producer, with Humma Humma winning at Group 3 level and stablemates Strela (Smart Missile), Hummalong (Hallowed Crown) and Tycoon Humma already victorious for the Morningside-based McArdle.

"She's probably a bigger, scopier filly than the rest of the family. The rest of the family are quite stocky and powerful, but she is a beautiful mover," the Group 1-winning trainer said.

"The older half-brother Strela, who unfortunately injured himself after six starts, he was a bit the same as this filly. She's a bit different to Humma Humma and Tycoon Humma, but she was a lovely filly.

"She's a valuable filly anyway, but if she could win black type she becomes very valuable."

Flinders Park's Mike Cumming knew a buyer would need deep pockets to outbid McArdle for the filly.

"He pretty much told me a couple of days ago that 'she is going home with me'. I said to him, 'you are going to have a bit of competition this time, Johnny',

and he spent \$240,000 on Tycoon Humma, and this one is the next level. He still wasn't fazed by what I said to him," Cumming said.

"She was more athletic, and with the same attitude as the mare. They can be pretty fiery when they race, they just love to race. That's what comes through them. She gives them a fair bit of attitude."

Laurie makes a \$2 million splash on day one

Victorian trainer Matt Laurie, who won the Oakleigh Plate (Gr 1, 1100m) with Deep Field (Northern Meteor) three-year-old colt Portland Sky last month, let the industry know that his rising stable is here to stay after buying four high-priced yearlings on day one.

The last of the quartet, and the most expensive, was a Yulong-bred and consigned Shalaa (Invincible Spirit) colt who made \$700,000 to Laurie and agent Justin Bahen.

The pair also bought a Lonhro (Octagonal) colt for \$460,000, a Deep Field filly for \$440,000 and a Frosted (Tapit) filly for \$420,000.

The Shalaa colt, the second highest-priced yearling sold yesterday, is the second foal out of Our Daisy (Commands), with her first, a two-year-old colt named Deep Snow (Deep Field), being trained in Sydney by Gerald Ryan and Sterling Alexiou.

"He was a lovely colt who had been well inspected and very popular, so we're really pleased for him to go in the ring and be sold to one of Victoria's leading young trainers in Matt Laurie," Yulong's Sam Fairgray said.

"Matt has some horses for us and he does a fantastic job with his attention to detail and so forth, so it is great that a colt like this is going into his stable."

Yulong has been a supporter in Arrowfield Stud's young shuttle stallion Shalaa, already the sire of this year's ATC Breeders' Plate (Gr 3, 1000m) and Magic Millions 2YO Classic (RL, 1200m) winner with first southern hemisphere crop son Shaquero, and has been handsomely rewarded with yesterday's sale result.

"We thought physically and on pedigree that he would suit, so we sent the mare to Shalaa," he said.

"We like the stallion and we're fortunate enough to get a beautiful type that the mare has left with this colt. Heading into the sale, we probably thought he was high \$200,000s, but we knew as the parade days went on there was lots of talk that he was one of the better colts here.

"He's a great moving horse and he had a lot of balance. It is what everyone is looking for, a horse who moves well and has the quality and strength about them."

Laurie spent \$2.02 million on day one but he could not fault his Shalaa colt.

"Obviously, Shalaa is going really well. I'm all about type and he fitted everything, I'm just pleased to have got him," Laurie said.

"He just confirmed what we saw of him on the farm on the sales complex. He has a wonderful temperament and is just a faultless specimen. Physically, he was just a great type. He's everything I look for.

"He is the style of horse that is just going to continue to furnish and progress. We've got a handful of Shalaas at home that we really like, and we are looking forward to getting them to the track, but I thought this was a special, special colt."

Meanwhile, the Silverdale Farm-consigned Deep Field filly is the first foal out of Iceland Turf Belle (Duporth) who is a half-sister to Listed winner Vinland (Sebring). She was offered as Lot 90.

The pair also bought a Lonhro colt earlier in the day for \$460,000 and a Frosted filly for \$420,000 after their Deep Field acquisition.

On the Deep Field filly, Laurie said: "She's a nice-sized

horse who is balanced, we like everything about her. Obviously we've had nice success with the sire, so we went hard for her.

"We've been able to have a good go over the past year or two with some nice stock and we've just added to that."

Laurie will not rush the filly, a \$100,000 purchase as a weanling by Suman Hedge and Grant Bloodstock from the Inglis Australian Weanling Sale, believing the Deep Field progeny improve as they get older.

"The Deep Fields show enough as two-year-olds,, but I have found that they maybe can't cop the work fully to race as two-year-olds and they are better three-year-olds, so I will just treat her as such," he said.

"There will be no pressuring her and she will tell us when she is ready."

Laurie suggested the market's ability to zero in on quality conformed, athletic yearlings was again on show at the Premier sale yesterday.

He said: "Any nice horse, regardless of their pedigree, if they're a good physical specimen they are well found and they are not always easy to buy."

The leading buyer on day one by numbers were Ciaran Maher and David Eustace who purchased ten yearlings headed by a \$480,000 Written Tycoon colt who the senior trainer declared was "stolen" at the price.

The Springmount-offered colt, catalogued as Lot 118, is the first foal out of La Haraka (Wicked Style), a half-sister to Group 3 winner Nina Haraka (Fraar) and Monte Rosa (Fraar), the dam of Group 1 winner Snitzerland (Snitzel), and Group 3-winning two-year-old Hard Landing (All Too Hard) as well as the promising first season sire Sooboog (Snitzel).

He is also from the same family as the Listed-winning, Group 1-placed Extension Of Time (Dash For Cash) and the stakes-placed Morrissy (Snitzel).

"I reckon we stole him. He's a ripping colt with a big pedigree. He's by Written Tycoon who is flying and he's got our

<< *Continued from page 8* best two-year-old (Enthaar) and thought he was (a potential) stallion of the future,” Maher enthused.

“He’s got the pedigree, he’s got the strength and a great attitude as well. Temperament is something that can hold a two-year-old back and he ticked all the boxes there and hopefully we see him lining up in the Slipper next year.”

Maher and Eustace spent a total of \$2.16 million yesterday. Other Victorian buyers to get their name on the sheet were prominent owner Nick Williams, who bought an American Pharoah (Pioneer of The Nile) colt from Mill Park Stud for \$180,000, and trainer Cliff Brown, who has returned to the state after a long stint in Singapore. Brown bought an All Too Hard (Casino Prince) colt for \$60,000 early in the day from Vinery Stud.

Record Premier trade as Victorians dominate the market

It was a record individual day’s trade for a Premier sale, with 233 yearlings changing hands for a combined \$23.27 million, up 20 per cent year-on-year, at an average of \$144,105 (up four per cent) and a median of \$110,000, which was down from \$120,000 on the same day in 2020. The clearance rate was a healthy 83 per cent.

“Simon (Vivian) was very bullish about the quality of the catalogue. He and Mark Dodemaide had seen the majority of it in the spring and we knew there were some more nice horses from interstate, but the enthusiasm for the horses here has really been fantastic,” Inglis general manager of bloodstock sales and marketing Sebastian Hutch said last night.

“It was a really enjoyable day, but the sale took a little bit of time to find its rhythm.

“There were some really good prices early on, it didn’t really quite flow in the manner you would like it to, but it just seemed to get stronger and stronger.

“The appetite for nice horses who vetted well was without fault almost insatiable and we reasonably expect it to continue (today).”

Eighteen yearlings made \$300,000 or more at last year’s Premier sale, but 15 have already made that mark with two sessions to go. The sale was also a demonstration of the strength of the Victorian market, with all but two of those expected to be trained in the state.

“Obviously, it’s a sale that they (Victorians) target very effectively on their home turf,” Hutch said.

“We’ve worked hard to put provisions in place to allow for people to be entertained and Victorians get here and they support the sale with great enthusiasm, as they do with any sporting or racing pursuit.”

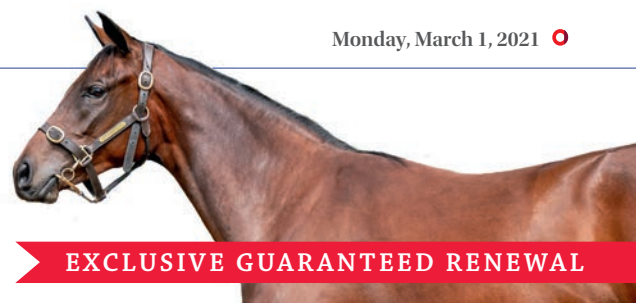

AUSTRALIA

Ole Kirk retired to Vinery Stud

Dual Group 1 winner Ole Kirk (Written Tycoon) has been retired to stud following his tenth-placed finish in Saturday's Australian Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m). The Team Hawkes-trained three-year-old landed the Golden Rose Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) and Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1400m) in the spring but has not been able to replicate that level of form this autumn. The son of Written Tycoon (Iglesia) will stand at Vinery Stud and finishes his career with three wins from eleven starts, for total prize-money of \$2,159,100.

Immediate racing plans for Lunar Fox in the air

Paul Preusker is yet to firm up a plan for shock Australian Guineas winner Lunar Fox (Foxwedge). The colt became the longest-priced Group 1 winner in Australian racing history when landing the Flemington feature at \$301 and connections are weighing up their next move. "We've got him in the All-Star Mile and we've got him in Sydney as well, he's got such a great temperament, we'll sit down with all the connections today and map out what really is priority," Preusker told RSN yesterday. "He's certainly going to improve again off a good tough run and having a go, they come off fit once they chip in, so he's entitled to improve again fitness wise. Hopefully we draw the right path."

George Ryder next for Tagaloa

The Trent Busuttin and Natalie Young-trained Tagaloa (Lord Kanaloa) will likely line up in the George Ryder Stakes (Gr 1, 1500m) at Rosehill on March 20 following his third-placed finish in

the Australian Guineas. Last year's Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner finished three-quarters of a length behind Lunar Fox and Young said he was brave in defeat. "He had to do some work early to get across and lead, he had to use himself up in the first 200 metres from the barrier," she told Racing.com "Then in the straight he was a sitting duck a long way out, there was nothing but space on either side of him and he's the sort of horse who needs a challenge. He was still very brave in defeat. We might look at the Group 1 George Ryder Stakes, the 1500 metres of that race is ideal."

Mystic Journey injured, set for extended spell

The Adam Trindler-trained Mystic Journey (Needs Further) is set for an extended spell after sustaining an injury that will require surgery in Saturday's Blamey Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m). The inaugural All-Star Mile (1600m) winner has suffered bone chips and bruising in a knee, forcing her off the track for at least four months. "It's very unfortunate, we knew something was wrong because she didn't finish off as she normally does," owner Wayne Roser told Racing.com. "She's got chips and bruising in her knee so that will unfortunately be her campaign this time, so she'll be out for four months after the operation which we hope is on Thursday (in Tasmania) and then will allow her time to recoup. We've spoken to the surgeon already and just talking to Adam (Trinder), I said 'she (Mystic Journey) wouldn't cope in Victoria without him (Adam)' and he said, 'she would but I wouldn't' so we're taking her back and he'll monitor her every day." Roser confirmed that Mystic Journey will continue to race on as a six-year-old next season. "We're in it to race and we love racing so as long as she can we'll continue to race, and she'll tell us when she doesn't want to race," he added.

Fifty Stars on track for Australian Cup defence

The Tom Dabernig and Ben Hayes stable were delighted with the performance of Fifty Stars (Sea The Stars) in the Blamey Stakes and are confident he is on track to defend his Australian Cup (Gr 1, 2000m) title at Flemington on Saturday. The six-year-old, who won the Blamey Stakes last year, finished a head behind Star of the Seas (Ocean Park). "What a run, it was almost more impressive than his win in the race last year, albeit not winning," Hayes told Racing.com. "It was fantastic to see him run so well second-up and he's right on track to defend his Australian Cup title next Saturday."

Black type on agenda for Inglis Dash winner Capriccio

Impressive Inglis Dash (1100m) winner Capriccio (I Am Invincible) is set to take her chance in stakes company on her next start, with her trainer Daniel Bowman keen to step the filly up in class. "The plan was to head to Adelaide for the Redelva and maybe the Euclase but we might have to recalibrate and have a closer look at the calendar and maybe raise the bar," Bowman told RSN. "It is really hard to know off those restricted races but Bella Nipotina and The Bopper had good form coming in and we beat them, who knows, I reckon we have a crack at some black type going forward now." The three-year-old was sent off a \$41 chance for the \$500,000 contest and defeated Group 3 winner Bella Nipotina (Pride Of Dubai) by three-quarters of a length. "I thought she was a ridiculous price having only had three starts," Bowman added. "The yard watchers might have found her which is why she was \$91 into \$41 late. Being first-up might have been a tough assignment but she copped a ten out of ten ride from Damian (Lane) and she was just too good for them."

War brings up the hat-trick in Wangaratta Cup

Declares War (Declaration Of War) continued his hot streak with a strong performance in the Wangaratta Cup (2000m) yesterday. The Matt Cumani-trained five-year-old followed up recent wins in the Camperdown Cup (1600m) and Birthday Cup (Listed, 2040m) with a one length success over Sikorsky (Pierro) in the \$100,000 contest. Strategic Phil (Strategic) was a further three lengths back in third. Declares War was a \$62,000 yearling purchase from the 2017 Magic Millions Yearling Sale and yesterday's win took his career earnings to \$457,370.

Bell-Pitomac overjoyed with Country Championship win

Kath Bell-Pitomac, the longest serving apprentice in Australia having started riding in 2002, was ecstatic after partner Old Harbour (Your Song) to victory in the Country Championships Qualifier (1400m) at Mudgee yesterday. The five-year-old gelding defeated Hamogany (High Chaparral) by a nose to earn his place in the \$500,000 Country Championships Final (1400m) at Randwick on April 3. "I know he has the ability and the heart but everything had to work and it did," Bell-Pitomac told Racing NSW. "Early on when he got his head up I thought 'I stuffed up here', halfway up the straight I thought 'I've stuffed up again, I've gone too early'. They're all passing me on pulling up asking if I got it, I said 'I just don't know' and I was waiting to hear (race caller) Col Hodges' voice. I'm stoked to be able to go down there to Sydney with him. I was lucky enough to go to Randwick the other week and that experience was amazing but this is another level."

Bivouac to have Kembla gallop

Three-time Group 1 winner Bivouac (Exceed And Excel) is set to have a raceday gallop at Kembla Grange tomorrow ahead of connections deciding on his next target. The James Cummings-trained four-year-old finished fifth in the Black Caviar Lightning (Gr 1, 1000m) on February 13 and Cummings is considering whether to line him up in the Canterbury Stakes (Gr 1, 1300m) or Challenge Stakes (Gr 2, 1000m) at Randwick this weekend. Glen Boss is set to ride Bivouac.

Addeybb en route to Sydney

Addeybb (Pivotal) has boarded a plane from Heathrow with stablemate Favorite Moon (Sea The Moon) as they make their way from the UK to Sydney. The William Haggas-trained Addeybb, winner of the Ranvet Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) and Queen Elizabeth Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) last year, will join up with stable staff from the Haggas yard in Sydney following the completion of their mandatory isolation period. Addeybb is likely to target the same two races he won last year and will be ridden by Tom Marquand, who began his latest Australian riding stint when drawing a blank at Randwick on Saturday.

Currie and Oliver suspended

Luke Currie is set to miss the All-Star Mile meeting at Moonee Valley on March 13 after pleading guilty to a careless riding charge at Flemington on Saturday. Currie was handed a ten-meeting suspension after causing interference aboard Tagaloa 400 metres after the start of the Australian Guineas. His suspension will begin following Saturday's Australian Cup meeting and he will be able to return on March 15. Damien Oliver also received a careless riding charge after causing interference aboard the unplaced Best Of Days (Azamour) in the Blamey Stakes. Oliver received an eight-meeting suspension, which will also begin after the Australian Cup meeting.

Second horse and rider expelled from series

The Nigel Blackiston-trained Translator (Helmet) has joined Spanish Snitzel (Chosir) as being ineligible for the Country Mile Race Series Final (1600m) after being whipped by his jockey Jake Noonan nine times - four over the limit of five - in the final qualifier at Wangaratta on Saturday. The first three placegetters of each heat qualify for the final at Moonee Valley on March 13 and Translator finished runner up to Fontein Diamond (Turffontein), whose jockey Patrick Monloney also broke the whip limit with five strikes. Noonan, along with his ride, will no longer be able to compete in the competition - with any horses struck eight times or more expelled - and received a nine-meeting suspension and a \$500 fine. Maloney was fined \$450.

NSW review point of consumption tax

The NSW government are reviewing the ten per cent point of consumption (POC) tax levied on punters in the state. Currently, Victoria has the lowest POC tax rate at 8 per cent, but that will increase to ten per cent on July 1, bringing it in line with NSW. SA, Queensland, the ACT, WA and Tasmania all currently have a 15 per cent POC tax. The review will look at the POC tax rate and threshold, existing wagering tax arrangements, racing industry funding arrangements implemented at the time of the POC tax introductions and any other policy related to the POC tax. The NSW government has called for submissions prior to March 24 and is expected to finalise its review by July 2021.

NEW ZEALAND

Richardson: 'It was quite a big night'

Matamata trainer Graham Richardson's celebrations following Saturday's Breeders' Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) win with Bonny Lass (Super Easy) continued well into the night, with the victory providing Richardson with one of his biggest thrills in racing. "I guess you can say that the Breeders' Stakes is the one race we all want to win," he said. "The competition is pretty fierce and to win it has given me one of my biggest thrills in racing. I don't often have too many two-year-olds as we like to give our horses time, but this filly is such a natural and so professional that she looked ideal for the race. I was really chuffed and the Swap family who sponsor the race are good mates and race several horses with me." Richardson had unsurprisingly not had time to respond to all the congratulatory calls and texts from the win. He added: "One of the other nice things about the win was the camaraderie amongst the locals after the race. I haven't even got close to answering all the texts and calls I've had, although I will be trying to do that on Sunday afternoon. I didn't get much sleep as we went to our local Italian restaurant to celebrate and it was quite a big night."

Tar And Cement set for Wellington Guineas

A comprehensive three-length victory at Matamata on Saturday has set promising three-year-old Tar And Cement (Reliable Man) on a path to the Wellington Guineas (Gr 2, 1400m) at Trentham next month. The Tony Pike-trained gelding made it two wins from two starts when he led all the way to score by three lengths over I'm Capable (Per Incanto). "He's a very promising type who has taken a while to get his act together," Pike said. "He's a pretty well put together horse who is quite versatile. He led in several of his trials but first-up at Hastings he bombed the start and came from well back to win. There wasn't a lot of pace in the race yesterday, so I left it up to Leith (Innes) as to how he would ride him. The track certainly suited those on the speed early on, so he let him bowl along and he did the job very nicely."

All roads lead to Te Aroha for Coventina Bay

Robbie Patterson believes he has Coventina Bay (Shamexpress) right where he wants her as he lines her up for a shot at the Thoroughbred Breeders' Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) at Te Aroha in April. The five-year-old landed the Lisa Chittick Plate (1400m) at Matamata on Saturday by a comfortable two lengths, a performance that delighted Patterson. "She has got such a turn of foot and she showed that again," the trainer said. "This time she got the breaks when she needed them and put them away nicely. She does need her races run to suit, but she is getting better every start and I think she was the best I have ever had her going into this race. She has pulled up really well this morning and is bouncing around and full of life." On her future targets, Patterson added: "Our main goal is the Thoroughbred Breeders' Stakes at Te Aroha in April so she can have one more run before then. I think that will most likely be in the Cuddle Stakes at Trentham on Oaks Day as it sits nicely three weeks out from Te Aroha."

Covid restrictions impact on NZ Derby

New Zealand Thoroughbred Racing (NZTR) and the Auckland Racing Club (ARC) held discussions yesterday regarding the impact of

Saturday's announcement that Auckland was moving back into Covid Alert Level 3 for seven days, starting from 6am yesterday morning. Of primary concern to the racing industry is the New Zealand Derby (Gr 1, 2400m), which was due to be run at Ellerslie this Saturday. Under the current status with Auckland at Alert Level 3 and the remainder of the country at Alert Level 2, the meeting is unable to be held at Ellerslie on that day. NZTR and the ARC's preferred solution is to move the Derby meeting to Sunday, March 7 in the hope that Auckland would move back to Alert Level 2 at the end of the seven-day period. "While this is the 'best case' scenario, it is by no means a certainty," NZTR CEO Bernard Saundry said. "We are continuing to work through different options should indications be that Auckland will not come out of Alert Level 3 at that time. Our focus, and that of the ARC, is to ensure that the country's blue riband event for our three-year-olds goes ahead."

ASIA

JPN: Resistencia strikes on return

Resistencia (4f Daiwa Major - Malacostumbrada ex Lizard Island) produced a remarkable performance to break the course record in yesterday's Hankyu Hai (Gr 3, 1400m) at Hanshin. Trained by Takeshi Matsushita, Resistencia returned from a break following an unplaced finish in the Mile Championship (Gr 1, 1600m) to score by two lengths over Mikki Brillante (Deep Brillante) in a time of 1m 19.20s. Gendarme (Kitten's Joy) was a further half-length behind in third. "She was strong," winning jockey Yuichi Kitamura said. "I expected her to run well today because her training was better in her four-year-old season than ever. I am relieved that I could win. I am looking forward to seeing her in the near future."

JPN: More joy for progressive Hishi Iguazu

Hishi Iguazu (5 h Heart's Cry - La Liz by Bernstein) followed up his Nakayama Kimpai (Gr 3, 2000m) win in January with victory in the Nakayama Kinen (Gr 2, 1800m) yesterday. The lightly-raced Noriyuki Hori-

trained five-year-old defeated Cadence Call (Lord Kanaloa) by a neck, with Win Exceed (Manhattan Cafe) another half a length back in third. The victory earned Hishi Iguazu his sixth win from 11 starts.

JPN: Blue hen Cesario dies at 19

Cesario (Special Week), who won Grade 1 races on two continents and has the distinction of producing three stallion sons at stud in Japan, died at Northern Farm on Saturday aged 19. Successful in both the Japanese and American Oaks (Gr 1, 10f) in 2005, the daughter of Special Week (Sunday Silence) was trained by Katsuhiko Sumii, who has in turn received her star progeny. From the paddocks Cesario has produced a list headed by Epiphaneia (Symboli Kris S), winner of the Japan Cup (Gr 1, 2400m) who has already sired the Japanese Fillies' Triple Crown heroine Daring Tact. Her other sons include Saturnalia (Lord Kanaloa), new to Shadai Stallion Station, and Leontes (King Kamehameha), whose first crop stars include last weekend's Saudi Derby (1600m) winner Pink Kamehameha.

INTERNATIONAL

82 for Ghostzapper

Fearless (5 g ex And Why Not by Street Cry) maintained his unblemished record at Gulfstream Park when landing the Gulfstream Park Mile Stakes (Gr 2, 1m) on Saturday to provide Ghostzapper (Awesome Again) with his 82nd individual stakes winner. The five-year-old gelding, who was having his first start in eight months, made it three from three at the Florida track when defeating Avant Garde (Tonalist) by three-quarters of a length. Performer (Speightstown) was another two lengths back in third. A half brother to the stakes winner Just Whistle (Pioneer of The Nile), Fearless was offered at the 2020 Fasig-Tipton July Horses of Racing Age Sale but went unsold for \$120,000. He is the second stakes winner of the three offspring of And Why Not (Street Cry) to race to date. Ghostzapper stands at Hill 'N Dale Farms in Kentucky \$85,000 (approx. AUD\$110,300).

Ten for Goldencents

Phantom Currency (5 g ex Phantom Rising by Mr Greeley) provided Goldencents (Into Mischief) with his tenth individual stakes winner when landing Gulfstream's Mac Diarmida Stakes (Gr 2, 11f) on Saturday. The Brian Lynch-trained five-year-old defeated favourite Tide Of The Sea (English Channel) by three-quarters of a length, with Moon Over Miami (Malibu Moon) another half a length back in third. The win was a fifth in 13 starts for Phantom Currency, who two starts previously had finished down the field in the Clark Stakes (Gr 1, 9f) at Churchill Downs. Bred in Kentucky by Sally Thomas and New Dawn Stable, Phantom Currency became the first stakes winner for the mare Phantom Rising (Mr. Greeley), who has three winners from her five foals to race. Goldencents, the sire of multiple Grade 2 winner By My Standards, stands at Spendthrift's US base for \$15,000 (approx. AUD\$19,500).

16 for Constitution

Florida Derby (Gr 1, 9f) winner Constitution (Tapit) sired his 16th individual stakes winner when his son Annex (3 c ex You Make Me Sing by Unbridled's Song) made it two wins from as many starts with a victory in the Palm Tree Stakes (Listed, 8.5f) at Gulfstream. Trained by Bill Mott, the colt followed up his debut win at the same track when beating Scarlett Sky (Sky Mesa) by a head. Chess's Dream (Jess's Dream) was a length and three-quarters further behind in third. Bred in Kentucky by William Harrigan and Mike Pietrangelo, Annex was a private purchase after he failed to meet his reserve when consigned by Lane's End to the 2019 Keeneland September Yearling Sale. He is the third foal and the only winner from three to race out of You Make Me Sing (Unbridled's Song), who produced an Honor Code (A.P. Indy) colt in 2019 and an Honor Code filly in 2020. She was bred to Mitole (Eskendereya) for 2021. Constitution stands at WinStar Farm in Kentucky for \$85,000 (approx. AUD\$110,315).

20 for Bodemeister

Arkansas Derby (Gr 1, 9f) winner Bodemeister (Empire Maker) took his tally of individual stakes winners to 20 when Wholebodemeister (3 f ex Wholelottashakin by Scat Daddy) scored for the third time in seven starts by taking out Gulfstream's Davona Dale Stakes (Gr 2, 1m). Sent off an unfancied 52-1 chance, the Juan Carlos Avila-trained filly belied her odds as she came home six and a half lengths clear of her nearest pursuer, Crazy Beautiful (Liam's Map), who in turn was another length and a half clear of third-placed Competitive Speed (Competitive Edge). Wholebodemeister is the sole winner from two starters for her dam Wholelottashakin (Scat Daddy), who produced an Arrogate (Unbridled's Song) colt this year and a Union Rags (Dixie Union) filly in 2020. Bodemeister stands at the Jockey Club Of Turkey's farm for €12,500 (approx. AUD\$19,585).

US: Greatest Honour books Derby berth

Greatest Honour (3 c Tapit - Tiffany's Honour by Street Cry) secured his place in the Kentucky Derby (Gr 1, 10f) with an emphatic victory in Gulfstream's Fountain of Youth Stakes (Gr 2, 8.5f). Ridden by Jose Ortiz, the three-year-old colt followed up his last-start victory in the Holy Bull Stakes (Gr 3, 8.5f) with a one and a half length win over Drain The Clock (Maclean's

Music). Papetu (Dialed In) was another two lengths away in third. The win earned Greatest Honour 50 qualifying points towards a start in the Kentucky Derby and, when added to the ten points he received for his Holy Bull victory, his total of 60 points puts him atop the leaderboard and assures him of a spot in the starting gate on the first Saturday in May.

US: Essential Quality back with a bang

The Godolphin-raced Essential Quality (3 c Tapit - Delightful Quality by Elusive Quality) made his seasonal return in style when taking out the Southwest Stakes (Gr 3, 8.5f) at Oaklawn Park on Saturday. The 2020 Champion 2YO Male slammed Spielberg (Union Rags) by four and a half lengths to extend his unbeaten record to four after wins in the Breeders' Futurity (Gr 1, 8.5f) and Breeders' Cup Juvenile (Gr 1, 8.5f) last year. Jackie's Warrior (Maclean's Music) finished eight and a half lengths behind the winner in third.

First for The United States

The United States (Galileo), a Group 1-winning brother to the high-class fillies Hermosa and Hydrangea, got his stud career off to the dream start on Saturday when Drakenstein Stud's homebred Sheela (2 f ex Trip To India by Trippi) made a winning debut in the Storm Bird Stakes (Listed, 1000m) at Turffontein in South Africa. The filly is out of Trip To India (Trippi) hailing from the family of European Group 1 winners such as Continent (Lake Coniston) and Zambezi Sun (Dansili). The globe-trotter began his racing career with Aidan O'Brien in Ireland before he transferred to the stable of Robert Hickmott to race for Nick and Lloyd Williams. He added his name to Galileo's 89 Group/Grade 1 winners when landing the 2016 running of the Ranvet Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m).

Silver Express emerges as Hong Kong Derby hope

Joao Moreira insists Silver Express (Canford Cliffs) warrants a tilt at the Hong Kong Derby (Listed, 2000m) next month after the grey forged into Classic calculations with runaway success in yesterday's Class 3 Tai Mei Tuk Handicap (1400m) at Sha Tin.

Committed to partner the Caspar Fownes-trained Sky Darci (Darci Brahma) in the March 21 feature, Moreira did little to disguise his admiration for the gelding after he demolished 13 rivals by leading virtually all the way in 1m 21.18s – well inside class and distance standard.

Crossing the line two and a quarter lengths ahead of Uncle Steve (Dabirsim) and Pure Legend (Written Tycoon), Silver Express will earn a vital rise in the handicap ratings as he atoned for a wayward second at his previous start by coursing truly in blinkers for the first time.

The emphatic nature of the performance – coupled with the open nature of this year's Derby – prompted Moreira to suggest John Size's lightly-raced galloper could rapidly emerge as a Classic contender.

"It's hard for me to say right now (if he's a Derby horse), but he deserves a chance – who knows if he can make it there," the Brazilian said after completing a double.

"Maybe John is going to run him again soon to try to give him a chance and the way he won today, even if he goes up in class, he should be competitive once again.

"If he wins again, he deserves buying a ticket for himself into the Derby because what else could you ask for a horse to be put in there?"

"There is nothing jumping out of the page for the Derby – it seems very open and who knows, he could be the one jumping out and making it very interesting."

Moreira was aware of the grey's antics at his previous start when he threw away certain victory by racing waywardly, but there were no problems with the addition of head gear.

"Of course, we were a bit worried about him doing what he did last time again," Moreira said.

"All we had in mind was to make sure that we don't upset him and the hope today was that he was tractable – and he was.

"He was kind – he didn't make my job hard at all today, it's a great training achievement."

The success delivered the final leg of a treble for Size, who overtook Fownes in the training championship to lead 47-46.

The 11-time champion trainer combined with Blake Shinn to land the Class 4 Wu Kau Tang Handicap (1400m) with Zone D (Holy Roman Emperor) before teaming with Moreira and Fantastic Way (Swiss Ace) in the Class 3 Pat Sin Leng Handicap (1200m).

Vincy's (Elzaam) upset win in the Class 3 Tai Po Kau Handicap (1800m) sabotaged the Derby hopes of Charity Fun (War Command), who needed to win to earn a ratings rise to have a chance of being selected.

Posting his first victory in 28 starts in Hong Kong, Vincy was patiently ridden by Frenchman Tony Piccone to deny Derby entrants Looking Great (Holy Roman Emperor) and California Ten (Rock Of Gibraltar), while Charity Fun finished eighth.

A winner of two of three starts in Ireland in 2017, Vincy – now seven – arrived in Hong Kong

burdened with much expectation but, until yesterday's breakthrough success, had posted seven seconds and a third.

"He came to Hong Kong with a bit of a reputation and I've only had him for a short while, albeit enough to learn a lot about him," winning trainer Douglas Whyte said.

"He certainly works a lot better in the mornings and he's indicated that he can do that (perform to his best) when he wants to.

"Today, everything went right and he got a beautiful pace – he was led into the race and only had to run home 400 metres – that's what he did.

"The winning move was the way Tony rode him," Whyte said.

Danny Shum and Alexis Badel combined to keep Winner Method's (Deep Field) unbeaten record intact as the gelding dispatched a talented field to win the Class 3 Nam Wan Handicap (1000m).

"He's a nice horse, I had to run the horse in Class 3 even though he beat Class 4 horses last start," Shum said. "I'll keep him at 1000 metres at Sha Tin."

Francis Lui is accustomed to the pressures of expectation through the deeds of stable star Golden Sixty (Medaglia D'Oro), but he was pleasantly taken by surprise with the victory of

Highly Proactive (Coats Choice) in the Class 2 Lam Tsuen Handicap (1400m).

The gelding held off Californiadeepshot (Deep Field) in a desperate finish under Karis Teetan – to Lui's delight.

"I didn't expect him to win," Lui said. "I'm surprised but he had a light weight (118lb) and he was given a good ride."

"There are no plans for him – just stay in this grade and see if he can win again."

David Hall successfully unveiled Summit Cheers (Zoustar) in the Class 4 Tai Po Market Handicap (1000m), 12 days after the promising young sprinter finished second to Group 1 winner Hot King Prawn (Denman) in a 1050-metre trial on the dirt at Sha Tin.

"He's a long way from being Hot King Prawn," Hall smiled.

"He's still learning and he doesn't know 100 per cent what he's doing yet - he showed his talent in the trials and obviously trialling alongside Hot King Prawn the other day became a bit of a talking point.

"He's still very much a work in progress and hopefully he'll continue to take benefit out of that."

Michael Chang is optimistic. Simply Spectacular (I Am Invincible), winner of the Class 4 Ting Kok Handicap (1200m), will progress to higher grades after overcoming

serious tendon issues to post his second Hong Kong win at just his third start.

"He's got the quality but he had a very bad tendon," Chang said. "Since he came to my stable, I would say he is nearly 100 per cent (sound)."

"He's a nice horse - if he stays sound, he can do something in Class 3

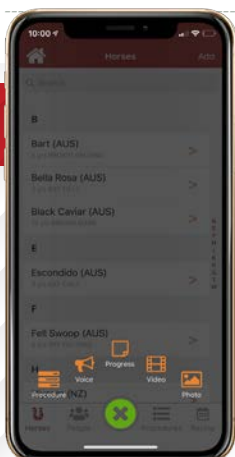
