Maher and Eustace continue juvenile domination in Sydney

*Away Game and Prague land Group 3 double to
strengthen Slipper hand*

A week after Cellsabeel's (Hinchinbrook) six-length romp at Rosehill, Ciaran Maher and David Eustace have strengthened their Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) hand as Away Game (Snitzel) and Prague (Redoute's Choice) landed a Group 3 double at Randwick yesterday.

Magic Millions 2YO Classic (RL, 1200m)

winner Away Game took out the first leg of the double, winning the Widden Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) by a comfortable margin of two and a quarter lengths ahead of the Chris Waller-trained Centimental (Snitzel), with Philizzy (Snitzel) a further neck away in third, marking a trifecta for Arrowfield Stud's leading sire Snitzel (Redoute's Choice).

171 for Redoute's Choice

The late champion stallion Redoute's Choice (Danehill) sired his 171st stakes winner yesterday as the Ciaran Maher and David Eustace-trained Prague (2 c Redoute's Choice ex Purely Spectacular by Pins) took out the Canonbury Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) at Randwick yesterday. The colt was having just his second race-start but his perfect record remains in tact after winning on debut at Canterbury. Arrowfield Stud announced the death of their resident sire Redoute's Choice at age 22 in March last year. The son of Danehill (Danzig) has ten lots catalogued at the Inglis Easter Yearling Sale in April. [Click here to view the catalogue.](#) *Morning Briefing page 6 >>*

Under visiting English jockey Tom Marquand, Away Game jumped from the widest barrier (5) and crossed the field to lead on the rails for the trip, before scooting away in the home straight to seal her third win in a row and book her ticket to next month's \$3.5 million juvenile feature.

Maher, who was on course for the win, said his valuable filly is unlikely to run again before her target race at Randwick on March 21.

"We'll see where she sits (in the elimination order) after this, we may not see her until then," he said. "She certainly doesn't need a lot of racing."

"She looked as if she was lost out in front there and he (Marquand) had to give her a little squeeze to go and cross (to the rail) and then it looked as if she was lost on the rail because she didn't see much of it at the Gold Coast.

"She's now a dual stakes winner very early in her career, she's a valuable little filly."

Away Game (2 f Snitzel ex Elusive Wonder by Elusive Quality) has now won three of four starts, all at stakes level, and amassed a total of \$1,327,800 in prize-money.

She was selected by Hannah Mathiesen and signed for by agent Kerri Radcliffe for \$425,000 at the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale from the Mill Park Stud draft.

One of five winners for the stakes-placed mare Elusive Wonder (Elusive Quality), Away Game is a sister to the Listed winner Modern

Wonder, who was trained by Leon and Troy Corstens, and was sold in 2018 for \$400,000 to Kia Ora Stud as a broodmare prospect.

Elusive Wonder has a yearling filly by Not A Single Doubt (Redoute's Choice) that was purchased by Aquis Farm for \$580,000 at last month's Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale, as well as a filly at foot by Merchant Navy (Fastnet Rock) and she returned to the same stallion this season, with a November 8 covering date.

Less than an hour later, Maher and Marquand were back in the winner's enclosure at Randwick after Prague landed the Canonbury Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m), the colt's second win from two starts.

The son of Redoute's Choice (Daneshill) was arguably even more impressive than his stablemate, winning by a length and three-quarters ahead of Chris Waller's Global Quest (More Than Ready) with the Gerald Ryan-trained Return With Honour (Fastnet Rock) a further neck away in third.

"I had a bit of a feeling about him today with the shades on and how he had come on in his coat from his first up run, there is a bit of timing about him," Maher said.

"Again, a great job by the team. Tom Marquand is riding up a storm. He's a very strong rider and had to feel a bit for him there because he got a bit lost when he hit the front."

Marquand rode the race to perfection, settling the Aquis Farm and Phoenix Thoroughbreds-owned colt on the *Continued on page 3>>*

<< *Continued from page 2* outside of leader Nitrous (Deep Field) after narrowly missing the start, and the jockey was impressed with what he felt beneath him.

"He jumped half a step slowly like his first run at Canterbury but popped up into the bridle relatively quickly," Marquand said.

"From three furlongs out (the 600-metre mark) there was little doubt as to what he was going to do and he was strong to the line.

"I'm sure that run will bring him on and he'll only improve out of it. Obviously the filly (Away Game) has probably shown some of her best hand already.

"She has shown she is extremely talented and extremely tough. But this lad has a hell of a lot of improving physically and mentally.

"They are two very nice horses going places and Ciaron has a stable full of good two-year-olds who are extremely well managed."

Prague's win provided Marquand with his 14th winner since arriving

in Sydney on January 4 for his summer stint while Maher and Eustace have now won 15 two-year-old races for the season.

"It's a very exciting time, the stable is going well. It's a young, enthusiastic great team and I'm very proud," Maher said.

Prague (2 c Redoute's Choice ex Purely Spectacular by Pins), was selected by Aquis Farm managing director Shane McGrath at the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale and purchased from the Bhima Thoroughbreds draft for \$1.6 million in conjunction with Phoenix Thoroughbreds.

One of five foals to race from the well-related mare Purely Spectacular (Pins), Prague is a half-brother to dual Group 1 winner Stratum Star (Stratum) as well as the stakes-placed Serenade (Star Witness).

Mildred back with Chairman's win

The decision to wait an extra week before beginning her autumn campaign paid off for Grahame Begg when Mildred (Hinchinbrook) took out the Chairman's Stakes (Gr 3, 1000m) first-up at Caulfield.

Mildred was initially meant to run in last week's Blue Diamond Preview (F) (Gr 3, 1000m) but feeling as though she was a gallop or two short of being race fit, 2018 Blue Diamond-winning trainer Begg elected to run the daughter of Hinchinbrook (Fastnet Rock) in yesterday's \$160,000 race instead.

Under Jordan Childs, Mildred was one of the best to break from the gates and lead the trip, holding off the Lindsay Park-trained Aryaaf (Epaulette) by a length with debutant Frederick The Dane (Danerich) a further four and a quarter lengths back in third.

"It's very exciting," Begg said.

"It just vindicated that we waited that extra week. I get more satisfaction out of that, making the right call.

"You can be a mug and make the wrong call plenty of times. But when you get it right, it's a big thing."

While the Chairman's Stakes is a typical lead-up race for the Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m), Begg said Mildred is likely to run in the Talindert Stakes (Listed, 1100m) at Flemington on February 15 although he hasn't ruled out backing her up in the \$1.5 million juvenile feature a week later.

"She backed up quickly from her first start to her second start so it's a very real possibility," he said.

"But we've got nothing set in stone. We might head to Sydney and possibly run in something up there. It's all about building her resume up. She's won a Listed and she's now won a Group 3."

Mildred (2 f Hinchinbrook ex Tempest Tost by Statue of Liberty) has had four starts for three wins, two of which have been at stakes level, earning a total of \$242,200 in prize-money.

She was purchased from the draft of Middlebrook Valley Lodge for \$45,000 by Neville Begg at the Inglis Classic Yearling Sale.

Mildred is the fourth winner out of the stakes-winning mare Tempest Tost (Statue Of Liberty) who herself is a half-sister to Group 1-winner Notoire (Export Price) and dual stakes *Continued on page 4>>*

Her half-brother by Deep Field (Deep Impact) was purchased by Patrick Lee at last month's Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale for \$400,000.

Her late sire Hinchinbrook has his final crop of yearlings going through the sale ring this year with 18 lots catalogued at the upcoming Inglis Classic Yearling Sale.

Son of Exceed And Excel Stands Out in Expressway

Gerald Ryan's flashy three-year-old colt Standout (Exceed And Excel) proved he is the real deal as he beat his elders when taking out the Expressway Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) at Randwick yesterday.

It was the first time the son of Exceed and Excel (Danahill) had raced outside of his age group and he emulated the deeds of former stablemate and Widden Stud-resident Trapeze Artist (Snitzel) who was the last three-year-old to take out the race.

Standout was settled fourth in the run, switching off nicely under Tommy Berry, before cruising into the race with 300 metres to go, winning by a length and a half ahead of the fast-finishing Alizee (Sepoy) with White Moss (Mossman) a further half-length back in third.

Chris Waller's Golden Eagle (1500m) winner Kolding (Ocean Park) was fourth.

"I was confident coming in he could do that, but you don't know until you try them," Ryan said.

"You've got Chris's horse (Kolding) who is probably one of the best horses in Australia and Alizee, who is probably the best mare in Australia and that little white thing (White Moss) never knows when to run a bad race.

"It was his test and sure, he's got to make the next level and take on the best horses, but he's got a Group 2 against his name now.

"He has always shown that he had Group 1 ability. He hasn't got there yet but he's certainly going to have a crack at it this autumn.

"A race like the Canterbury Stakes could be on the agenda and I've had luck in the TJ (Smith Stakes) with Melito and Trapeze Artist as three-year-olds."

Standout (3 c Exceed and Excel ex Bahia by Snippets) has won four of his five starts with his only defeat coming at the hands of Cosmic Force (Deep Field) in the Roman Consul Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) where he finished second. He has amassed a total of \$315,365 in prize-money.

Bred and raced by George Altomonte's Corumbene Stud, he is a brother to Golden Slipper Stakes winner Overreach and Widden Stud's resident Outreach, who sired his first winner on Thursday.

The fifth winner out of Bahia (Snippets), Standout is also related to Blue Diamond Stakes winner Reward For Effort (Exceed And Excel) as well as Group 3 winner Charmed Harmony (Hussonet).

Corumbene Stud are offering the brother to Standout at the Inglis Easter Yearling Sale as **Lot 342**.

Seth returns with Super Manfred win

Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Super Seth (Dundeel) returned where he left off after posting an impressive first-up win in the Manfred Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) at Caulfield.

Similar to his Guineas win, the Anthony Freedman-trained colt ran down last year's Blue Diamond Stakes runner-up Free Of Debt (Unencumbered) in the final stages of the race, scoring by a length and a quarter with Dalasan (Dalakhani) running on for a neck third.

Freedman considered scratching his Waikato Stud-bound colt after a heavy downpour of rain significantly affected the track, but Super Seth added another feather to his cap, proving he can handle wet ground.

"It was an impressive performance," Freedman said.

"I wasn't too sure about the ground but the Dundeels can generally get through it and it opens up a possibility in Sydney if they get rain up there.

"He seems to have come back at least as good."

Jockey Mark Zahra believes Super Seth has improved again and said the three-year-old had a real will to win.

"A lot of horses would have given up at the furlong because the leader gave a good kick but once I got within a half-length he just took off, he knows where the finishing line is," Zahra said.

"He's come back bigger and better than ever."

<< *Continued from page 4* Chaparral) next run is likely to be in the C S Hayes Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) at Flemington on February 15 before he heads to his ultimate target in the Australian Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m).

Following his win in the Caulfield Guineas, New Zealand's Waikato Stud secured a majority share in Super Seth to stand him at their farm once he retires and the stud's Mark Chittick said he was nervous leading

into yesterday's race.

"When Mark (Zahra) cruised past the leader at the 100-metre mark, it was a great feeling of relief, hugely satisfying," Chittick said.

"When you become involved in a horse under these circumstances, buying into them as a stallion proposition, I definitely felt a lot of added pressure ahead of today's race. There's no hiding, it's a lot of money.

"But he's such a quality colt, he really is. I can't wait to see him keep racing and hopefully add some more Group 1s to his name hopefully before coming here to Waikato for his stallion days."

Super Seth's (3 c Dundee ex Salutations by Redoute's Choice) record now sits at five wins from eight starts for \$1,512,100 in prize-money. With his stallion future locked in, the \$280,000 paid by New Zealand agent Dean Hawthorne at the Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale looks a lucrative investment.

Super Seth's dam Salutations (Redoute's Choice) is also the mother of the Hawkes Racing-trained dual Listed winner Wild Planet (Animal Kingdom).

Super Seth's second dam is the Group 2 winner Toast Of The Coast (Rory's Jester), who was trained by Tony Vasil, while his third dam Solo Show (Dahar) was a Herbert Power Stakes (Gr 2, 2400m) winner.

Super Seth's sister was purchased for \$70,000 at last year's Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale by Sandra *Continued on page 5>>* Harding and she is now in training with Peter and Paul Snowden at Randwick.

Salutations had a Dundee colt last spring and was bred back to the six-time Group 1 winning son of High Chaparral (Sadler's Wells) in 2019.

John Messara of Arrowfield Stud, who bred Super Seth, said he was thrilled with the colt's return win.

"We're proud of Super Seth as one of our 12 Group 1-winning Inglis Easter graduates since 2013 and we look forward to presenting six Dundee yearlings in our Classic draft and eight at this year's Inglis Easter Sale."

Jungle Edge relishes wet in Adams

Wet-track specialist Jungle Edge (Dubawi) relished the rain-affected course at Caulfield yesterday as he took out the W J Adams Stakes (Listed, 1000m) and in the process provided dual licence holder Jade Darose with her first stakes winner in a career spanning 20 years in the saddle. With the track downgraded from good to the soft range, Darose steered the Mick Bell-trained outsider to a length win from I Am Immortal (I Am Invincible) with Causeway Girl (Shamus Award) another half-head away third. "It's so exciting, especially for Mick, he's been so good to me and today was my lucky day," Darose said. "I've ridden this horse in trackwork for five years. He's probably the best horse I've ridden because I've ridden mainly in the bush and those horses don't measure up here. It is disappointing that I haven't been on him before. You do get your hopes up and you go through a series of different thoughts, but Mick's good to me and this horse, I just love."

First city win for Nonconformist

Grahame Begg believes Nonconformist (Rebel Raider) can keep stepping up after the progressive three-year-old backed up a recent big-margin maiden win with a first city victory in yesterday's John Moule Handicap (1600m) at Caulfield. Following yesterday's two and a half length win, Begg is planning on returning with Nonconformist in three weeks time to take on the Autumn Classic (Gr 3, 1800m). "This is only his first preparation so it's exciting," the trainer said. "You'd like to think he will keep on getting that bit better with racing but I'm also mindful it's only his first racing

preparation. He's always been a work in progress. I hate to say it but he's been very dumb in the head but he's coming around and each time he goes to the races he's getting that bit better. He's come a long way in his first preparation to be running in town on a Saturday."

Just Benjamin fights off rivals for victory

European import Just Benjamin (Epaulette) got his head in front on his second Australian start when he posted a hard-fought win under Damian Oliver in yesterday's Mal Seccull Handicap (1800m) at Caulfield. Having been sent to the front early, the Anthony Freedman-trained gelding dug deep in the closing stages to defeat Sam Slick (Strategic) by a long head with fellow European import, Aktau (Teofilo), a further head away third. "I think he got over-racing early and the only way he could get him to relax was take him to the front," Freedman said. "I think he (Oliver) thought it was a very messy race, but I didn't leave him with any instructions and great jockeys make those decisions. The horse got a bit strong early so he let him roll a bit to get him to relax, but I don't think that's the way to ride him. He's got the win on the board now so we can look done the track for other races."

Diamond Effort reveals Caulfield wet

Diamond Effort (Mossman) revelled in the soft conditions at Caulfield to post a dominant four-length win on her return from a spell in yesterday's Robert Hunter Handicap (1100m). "She had done everything right leading into the race so we were pretty confident she would be very hard to beat," trainer Clinton McDonald said. "We'll just have a look but we'll probably try to find another mares' race for her and I just said to the owners we might have to put her away because if she likes the wet that much we might have a look at The Wangoom." McDonald knows what it takes to win the Listed handicap at Warrnambool's May Carnival, having landed back-to-back victories in the race in 2012 and 2013 on rain-affected ground with Diamond Effort's sister Second Effort.

Vaocluse Bay posts second win in eight days

A rise in weight and distance was not enough to stop Vaocluse Bay (Al Maher) from registering a second victory at Caulfield in the space of eight days as he took out the All Star Mile @ MRC March 14 Handicap (2400m) under a well-judged front running ride from Linda Meech. Trainer Chris Waller's Melbourne representative Johanne Taylor said the soft track had played to Vaocluse Bay's advantage. "At the 2400 metres today Chris thought he might have been a touch suspect, so Linda had to really judge the pace well," Taylor said. "She did that and the way he (Vaocluse Bay) did it today you could imagine that he could go on with it. The soft surface today also played in his favour and on that he should be able to handle a rise in distance going into the future."

Group 1 ambitions for Subpoenaed

Chris Waller has Group 1 ambitions for progressive filly Subpoenaed (Rip Van Winkle) after she resumed with a strong win over older rivals at Randwick. Starting a popular \$1.65 favourite, the three-year-old gave backers no cause for concern as she won yesterday's Sky Racing Active Handicap (1400m) by a length and three-quarters. "We thought she would be a nice three-year-old filly in the autumn, I'd be having a little look at a race like the Vinery with her," Waller said. "I know it's a bit ambitious, a Group 1 three-year-old fillies race, but that's what we bought her for so we'll set these horses for these races. If she can get 2000 metres I think she will have no problem winning a nice race."

43 for Stratum

The late stallion Stratum (Redoute's Choice) landed his 43rd stakes winner yesterday when Vamos Raffa (3 g ex Villa De Madrid by Mossman) took out the Tasmanian Derby (Listed, 2200m) at Hobart. The Scott Brunton-trained gelding defeated Skyt (Nicconi) by two lengths with Argyle Beach (Purrealist) a further half-length away in third. Stratum, winner of the 2005 Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) stood at Widden Stud and died of a heart attack in 2016, aged 14.

Cup Night lands Scenic Blast

The Bernie Miller-trained Cup Night (4 g Maschino ex Walk In Beauty by Barely A Moment) landed his second stakes victory when winning the Scenic Blast Stakes (Listed, 1200m) at Ascot yesterday. The four-year-old defeated Simon Miller's Valour Road (Frost Giant) by two and a quarter lengths with Saracino (Per Incanto) finishing a further quarter of a length away in third.

Options open for Uncle Frank

Toowoomba trainer Steve Kirkwood has some decisions to make with Uncle Frank (Falvelon) following the improving two-year-old's impressive three and a quarter length win in yesterday's QTIS two-year-old handicap (1000m) at Eagle Farm. "He has improved since his previous start and there is more

improvement in him," Kirkwood said. "Uncle Frank takes after his sire Falvelon as he has pace and always shows plenty of fight." The gelding is eligible for the \$500,000 QTIS Jewel (1200m) at the Gold Coast on March 15, a race now under consideration. "The Jewel is certainly an option but we won't get too far ahead of ourselves," Kirkwood added.

Cool Chap caps big week for Heathcote

Robert Heathcote proved himself to be a top judge when Cool Chap (High Chaparral) followed up his recent win with a length and a quarter victory in yesterday's Osmin Handicap (1840m) at Eagle Farm. Heathcote had predicted the seven-year-old would win yesterday's race after the gelding scored his first victory in two years a fortnight earlier. "Horses really are funny. They can go 800 days without a win and then put two on end," he said. "But I always felt when he won one race he would string a few together. He has won \$84,000 this campaign which is like winning a Listed or Group 3 race."

Gresham ends winless drought

The tough Chris Waller-trained gelding Gresham (Sebring) got his head in front for the first time in over a year when he notched a three and a quarter length win in yesterday's Eva Air Plate (1600m) at Eagle Farm. Waller's Queensland manager Paul Shailer said: "Gresham hasn't had much luck and missed the start badly last time. I think we will keep him to races around 1600 metres but that is up to Chris."

Shalwa to concentrate on softer summer races

Tony Gollan intends to make the most of the weaker off-season races with stud-bound mare Shalwa (O'Reilly) after her comfortable length and a half victory over inferior horses in yesterday's Queensland Chinese Jockey Club Plate (1200m) at Eagle Farm. "She had a lot on them and obviously can win something a bit better," Gollan said. "But I don't think she is up to the winter so we will make hay while the sun shines in these races at the end of the summer. She is being sold as a broodmare and she has some black-type so a few more wins will help."

Autumn setback for Yes Yes Yes

Chris Waller will wait for the results of veterinary tests this week before making a decision on the immediate future of The Everest (1200m) winner Yes Yes Yes (Rubick). The colt missed a scheduled exhibition gallop at Randwick yesterday after inflammation was discovered in his near foreleg. Waller immediately notified stewards who ordered that betting be suspended on races in which Yes Yes Yes was highly positioned in markets. "We just noticed he had a little bit of heat in his leg this morning and we dare not take risks with horses, full stop," Waller said. "I just want to see where the heat is coming from. The vets will do their checks and work out what the story is and whether he misses a run or whether he has a delayed prep or whatever. I don't know any more than that really."

Fall mars double for Marquand

English jockey Tom Marquand had a day of mixed fortunes at Randwick yesterday which started with a Group race double and ended with a hospital visit. After starting the day on a high with wins aboard Away Game (Snitzel) and Prague (Redoute's Choice), Marquand's luck took a turn for the worse when he hit the ground heavily after his mount Ronstar (Zoustar) clipped heels near the 800 metre-mark in the Ranvet Handicap (1400m). Racing NSW doctor John Saxon said Marquand was complaining of a sore shoulder and neck and he was sending him to hospital as a precaution. "He's also showing some signs of concussion so I am organising for him to go up to the hospital and get assessed," Saxon said.

Heat and rain force meeting abandonments

Contrasting weather conditions claimed two provincial meetings yesterday, one in New South Wales and one in Victoria. Racing at Newcastle in NSW was called off with the temperature hitting 41 degrees which was higher than originally estimated. Trainers who had travelled their horses from Sydney, and senior jockeys, met with stewards before the first scheduled race and all agreed to abandon the meeting. In Victoria the provincial meeting at Kyneton was abandoned after six races because of visibility issues. The meeting started on a good-rated track before it was downgraded to heavy following the rain which eventually led to the meeting being abandoned.

NEW ZEALAND

First for Sweynesse

Novara Park-based stallion Sweynesse (Lonhro) sired his maiden stakes winner yesterday as Bonita Aurelia (2 f ex Cassie May by Red Clubs) took out the Woburn Classic (Gr 3, 1200m) at New Plymouth. The Group 1 runner-up has had just six runners and stood for a fee of \$6,000 (inc GST) in 2019.

\$500 filly lands Taranaki 2YO feature

Lightly-raced filly Bonita Aurelia landed her first win when she downed her better fancied rivals in yesterday's Woburn Farm 2YO Classic (Gr 3, 1200m) at New Plymouth. Rider Danielle Johnson had her mount settled midfield throughout before issuing a challenge midway down the home straight and going on to win by half a length from Piaggio (Vespa). Amoisia (Squamosa) was a further three-quarters of a length away in third. "She's been a promising filly right through," said Murray Baker who trains in partnership with Andrew Forsman. "We've had to blindfold her and play around but the funny thing is she might be the quietest horse we've got. We thought she was a big chance today." Bonita Aurelia was a bargain buy for her owners who paid just \$500 for her as a weanling at the 2018 Karaka May Sale. Yesterday's win added \$43,750 to her prize-

money earnings along with some valuable black type.

First for Ghibellines

White Robe Lodge stallion Ghibellines (Shamardal) sired his first stakes winner when El Gladiador (3 g ex Querella by Haafiz) landed yesterday's Dunedin Guineas (Listed, 1500m) at Wingatui. Standing for a service fee of \$6,000, Ghibellines has sired three individual winners to date. El Gladiador, who was his sire's first-ever winner when scoring on debut in December 2018, now heads that list, while Live Drama and Ranger have both placed at Listed level.

El Gladiador leads the trip in Guineas upset

El Gladiador (Ghibellines) made virtually all the running under Tina Comignaghi to post a surprise victory in yesterday's Dunedin Guineas (Listed, 1500m). Comignaghi, who held herself responsible for not finishing closer when the pair were a running-on seventh in last month's Gore Guineas (Listed, 1335m) moved her mount forward from gate 10, taking the lead after 100 metres and dominating the race from there. "I didn't ride him very well in the Gore Guineas," Comignaghi said of the John and Karen Parsons-trained gelding. "I got too far back, but he still ran home really well. I think he's better ridden this way. He's quite a laid-back horse and tends to get back, but if you go forward out of the gate, you can take luck out of the question." El Gladiador finished a length and a half in front of Tears On Of Angel (Echoes Of Heaven) with the same distance back to All About Magic (Showcasing) in third.

Four for Roc de Cambes

The Oaks Stud-based stallion Roc de Cambes (Red Ransom) sired his fourth individual stakes winner yesterday when Seven Seas (3 f ex Just Keeper by Keeper) took out the Taranaki Oaks Prelude (Listed, 1800m) at New Plymouth. Standing for a fee of \$5,000 in 2019, Roc de Cambes is responsible for New Zealand Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) winner Vin De Dance as well as Toorak Handicap (Gr 1, 1600m) winner He's Our Rokkii.

Seven Seas wins Oaks trial in blanket finish

Cambridge visitor Seven Seas (Roc De Cambes) stormed home to come out on top in a desperately tight finish in the Taranaki Oaks Prelude (Listed, 1800m) at New Plymouth. Less than half a length separated the first six runners home with the gallant Nothing Compares (Jakkalberry) going down by a nose in second and Heart Of The Ocean (Tavistock) a head back in third. "It was a superb run as she has been a work in progress all the way through and we were throwing her in the deep end a little," trainer Tony Pike said. "You'd have to press ahead to the Oaks with her now after that run. She is a dead-set stayer so the 2400 metres will be right up her alley. She will have one more run which is likely to be in the Sunline Vase (Gr.3, 2100m) at Ellerslie on February 29 as it's a race that suits her programme and one we have used for this task in the past."

Taranaki Cup to Prise De Fer

Prise De Fer (Savabeel) extended his winning sequence to five with an impressive performance in yesterday's Taranaki Cup (Gr 3, 1800m) at New Plymouth. Ridden by Opie Bosson, the Jamie Richards-trained four-year-old settled in the second half of the field before going on to win by three-quarters of a length from Jessieggee (Alamosa). Guillada (Guillotine) was another half a length away in third. "He's a promising horse," Richards said. "It takes a fairly good animal to put five together, and he's certainly getting through the grades really nicely. I'm not sure that he's a 2000-metre horse at the moment, although he could probably do it. I think a mile is a better trip for him at the moment."

Four for Road To Rock

Wellfield Lodge resident Road To Rock (Encosta De Lago) sired his fourth individual stakes scorer yesterday courtesy of a win for Sitarist (5 m ex Sita by Bertolini) in the Dunedin Gold Cup (Listed, 2400m) at Wingatui. The dual Group 1 winner, whose son Beauty Generation has landed multiple Group races in Hong Kong, stood for a fee of \$5000 (plus GST) in 2019.

Sitarist takes out Dunedin Gold Cup

Emerging staying mare Sitarist (Road To Rock) prevailed in a thrilling finish to the Dunedin Gold Cup, which formed the middle-leg of wins in all three of the black-type races at Wingatui for trainers John and Karen Parsons and jockey Tina Comignaghi. However, the five-year-old's narrow victory over Mr Intelligence (Niagara) was nearly derailed by a setback. "She was lucky to make it to the race," Karen Parsons said. "She'd been battling a foot infection, and it was only on Thursday that the blacksmith gave her the green light to run."

95 for O'Reilly

The late Waikato Stud stallion O'Reilly (Last Tycoon) sired his 95th individual stakes winner when Killarny (7 g ex Irish Colleen by Shinko King) landed the White Robe Lodge WFA (Gr 3, 1600m) at Wingatui yesterday. Bred by part-owner Daniel Nakhle and his father Elias, Killarney is out of the well-performed racemare Irish Colleen who won seven races including the Concorde Handicap (Gr 2, 1200m).

Wingatui clean sweep for Comignaghi and Parsons team

The combination of trainers John & Karen Parsons and rider Tina Comignaghi completed a clean sweep of the three stakes races at Wingatui when Killarney (O'Reilly) scored in the White Robe Lodge WFA. The injury-plagued seven-year-old has made a fine start to 2020 with yesterday's win providing him with a second success of the year. "He is such a neat old horse and one we've had some real ups and downs with," breeder and co-owner Daniel Nakhle said. "He showed enormous promise early on but an injury to his stifle has plagued him for three seasons so to get this many starts out of him is just amazing. We were looking at retiring

him last year after another setback. It's a dream come true and I'm absolutely stoked about it." Shirley Maude (Fully Fledged) finished two and a half lengths behind in second, with another long neck back to Belle Fascino (Per Incanto) in third.

Bangkok impresses in Lingfield romp

Bangkok (4 c Australia ex Tanaghum by Darshaan) proved to be a cut above his rivals when he ran out an impressive winner of the Winter Derby Trial Stakes (Listed, 1m2f) on his all-weather debut at Lingfield yesterday.
