## Buyers hold upper hand after day one of 'polarising' Magic Millions National Yearling Sale

*Clearance rate cops a hit at end-of-the-line sale as market struggles to find happy medium*

**M**agic Millions will attempt to cultivate a happy medium between buyers and sellers after a "far from satisfactory" start to the Magic Millions National Yearling Sale as purchasers appeared unwilling to compromise on quality despite apparent unprecedented demand for racing stock.

After months of vendors holding court at the Australian yearling and breeding stock

sales, buyers took the upper hand yesterday, leading to a depressed clearance rate which hovered around the 50 per cent mark for most of the six hours of trade which saw seven select sale yearlings make \$200,000 or more.

A Snitzel (Redoute's Choice) colt was the most expensive yearling at \$500,000 while a son of I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit) sold for \$320,000 and a Dundee (High Chaparral) colt and an Extreme Choice (Not A Single Doubt) filly made \$220,000 each on the opening day.

Magic Millions managing director Barry Bowditch cut to the chase last night when assessing the session.

"I think it's an extremely polarising market and the clearance rate is far from satisfactory and over the next 24 hours we'll be working very hard to increase the clearance rate to a satisfactory level," Bowditch said.

"Buyers, agents, trainers and owners out there need to be paying attention to this sale. They need to be doing their research overnight leading into (today and tomorrow) because there's so much opportunity

out there.

"On the other side of the coin, I think vendors need to set their reserves low and give the market an opportunity to gain some confidence and obviously give themselves an opportunity to sell these horses."

Last night, 111 yearlings had been sold for a total of \$7,091,500 at an average of \$63,887 (up 19 percent year on year) and a median of \$45,000

(up 25 per cent year on year). The clearance rate had improved to 57 per cent by the close of business with the expectation more sales will be made today.

Bowditch understood the reasons why many buyers, even in the absence of a number of Victorian participants, were not prepared to exceed their budgets to purchase horses.

"I think they're being selective. They are at an end-of-the-line yearling sale," he said.

They don't need a lot of horses, so they are pinning their ears back on the ones they really like.

"I think quality lots were still sought after today and that was evident whether it be Guy Mulcaster and Chris Waller or Suman Hedge, they've got an eye for detail and they're finding those horses here and making sure they secure them."

### Third time lucky for Milburn's \$500,000 Snitzel colt

The session-topping colt changed hands in the dying moments of the day with Victorian agent Suman Hedge going hard for a son of Snitzel, a colt offered by John Muir's Milburn Creek, after twice having to be withdrawn from earlier yearling sales.

Hedge had to go to \$500,000 to land the colt after strong competition from an online bidder.

"We had a lot of insider knowledge about this horse. Scott (Holcombe from Milburn Creek) has been telling me about this horse for a very long time about how much he loved him," Hedge said.

"They were devastated that they couldn't get him through the sales earlier in the year, which was really bad luck that he didn't come through.

"Had he gone through earlier he would have made significantly more, so armed with all that knowledge and seeing his pedigree, we thought he was clearly the standout horse here, comfortably."

The colt, who had to be withdrawn from both the Magic Millions Gold Coast and Inglis Australian Easter Yearling sales owing to niggling issues, is the fifth foal out of stakes winner Walk With Attitude (Hussonet) who is already the dam of the stakes-placed two-year-old winner Spend (Snitzel), himself a \$1.55 million Easter graduate. He was catalogued as Lot 1619.

Hedge would not disclose the ownership group behind the high-priced purchase while a trainer has not been decided.

"We had him vetted and our vets were really happy with him and we've got a pretty strict criteria. With our pinhooking and yearlings, we are very, very conservative by nature and they were all very happy with him," he said.

"He presented very well. He's a lovely moving horse, he's strong, he's active. He paraded as well today as he did on the first day, so they are all the signs of a good horse."

## Hedge moves on Extreme Choice collector's item

Earlier, an endorsement from trainer Mick Price was enough for Hedge to buy an Extreme Choice filly, who will now head to Victoria to the stable who prepared the exciting sire whose yearlings are a "limited edition".

Hedge, on the Gold Coast but bidding via the phone through Magic Millions consultant Ben Culham, went to \$220,000 on behalf of a client to purchase the Bowness Stud-consigned filly and he confessed to having more money for her if required.

Price and his training partner Mick Kent Jr also signed on for the filly.

"We thought she was very reminiscent of the sire. Mick Price, who is going to train her, trained Extreme Choice and when we saw her we asked him what he thought and he said, 'she's all Extreme Choice,' so we think she's an ideal type to get broken in and she will be nice and early," Hedge said.

"The stallion is doing such a good job - his numbers are through the roof - so when we were trying to value her we just thought, 'how would you value an I Am Invincible, a Snitzel or a Zoustar?' because we value Extreme Choice in the same way.

"In that context, we were quite comfortable with where we were (price wise)."

Catalogued as Lot 1553, the filly is the first foal out of four-time winner She Brings Hope (Sebring) who was trained by Peter Moody and then David Brideoake.

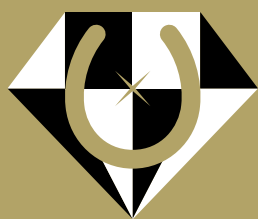

<< *Continued from page 4* "We will probably put something together to race her, but the client will hopefully breed from her later on," Hedge said.

"We see that any progeny from this sire is a bit of a collector's edition because there's only going to be so many available by him, so when we saw a filly by him that we liked physically we wanted to try and get hold of her.

"We've bought two breeding rights in Extreme Choice in the past week and we've bought a number of his yearlings and foals as well.

"He is just a horse who has made a good impression."

Extreme Choice, whose fertility issues have led Newgate to restrict his book to shareholder and foal share breeders this year, is the first crop sire of Golden Slipper (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Stay Inside and Saturday's BRC Sires' Produce Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) winner Tiger Of Malay.

He has five individual winners, three of them stakes winners, from just 13 runners.

The filly's \$220,000 sale price was a big result for Bowness Stud's John North who passed her in with a reserve of \$50,000 at the January Magic Millions sale. He had paid just \$2,500 for her dam She Brings Hope at the 2018 Inglis Great Southern Sale.

"We were very fortunate. She is the first foal of the mare and they're not necessarily early January, forward precocious types of January yearlings and I thought she just needed a little bit more time to grow and mature into herself, which is what she's done," North said.

"She presented a lot better at this sale than she did in January and, of course, the stallion's gone from strength to strength winning the Slipper and the Sires' the other day.

"He's a remarkable stallion, so it's just a pity he's got these fertility issues, but I've never had any problems with him even though a lot of people have."

Given the weaker-than-expected market yesterday, North was pleasantly surprised by the filly's price.

"It's a very soft market today, so I had pretty low expectations. I thought if I could get to \$80,000 I'd be happy, but she's more than doubled that, and I think she's up where she deserves to be," he said.

"Given the way the stallion's going I think that is a very fair result."

Questioned about the overall market, North said: "I suppose the money's still around, but it's probably perception as well. This sale is always perceived to be the second stringers and the B-graders, but there are a lot of nice horses here today that haven't been making what they deserve to make.

'I am saying that from a vendor's point of view, so I might be wrong, and there's no denying the market. The market is what it is and you've just got to accept it or have a plan B, which a lot of people seem to have."

## Torryburn's I Am Invincible colt joins half-sister at Waller stable

An I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit) colt will join his older half-sister, the Group 3-placed Centimental (Snitzel), at Chris Waller's stables after the premier Sydney trainer's long-time agent Guy Mulcaster bought the yearling for \$320,000 at the Gold Coast sale yesterday.

Mulcaster and Waller combined to buy three of the top five lots sold on day one, with the Torryburn Stud-bred and consigned I Am Invincible colt the most expensive of the three purchases.

He is the third foal out of New Zealand Group 2-winning and Group 1-placed mare Serena Miss (Iffraaj) whose first foal Centimental, who was runner-up in last year's Widden Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) and won at Wyong last month, her second victory from 13 starts.

Serena Miss' second foal, a two-year-old gelding by Snitzel, is also being trained by Waller.

"I thought he'd make a bit more but I had seen the horse going into Easter, but he couldn't get there and I had spoken to Chris a couple of times this week and we thought he was nearly a 'must-have' so we will give him a chance in the system," Mulcaster said.

"There were a lot of horses who had got to other sales for various reasons but we'd already seen them and we liked them, so we took it from there."

## Waller to train final Redoute's Choice through ring

The final Redoute's Choice (Danehill) yearling to be offered at public auction was sold yesterday, bringing an end to a remarkable sales career for the champion Arrowfield Stud stallion.

The first lot through the ring, the colt is the second living foal out of Japanese mare La Fouine Tail (Neo Universe) and, after being passed in at the Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale in April, he was yesterday bought for \$210,000 by Mulcaster, with Waller to train the colt.

"He is a big, strong colt, he moves well, he has a big girth on him and we've had some pretty good ones by the same sire like The Autumn Sun, so hope he does a good job," Mulcaster said.

"We have seen these horses at other sales and at that sort of money, I thought he was pretty good value."

With a deep Japanese pedigree, the colt's second dam is champion three-year-old filly Fabulous La Fouine (Fabulous Dancer) and his third dam, Mercalle (Kaldoun), was Europe's champion older female stayer in 1990.

"We're delighted he's gone to a great home. He's a lovely colt and his second and third dams are both champions over a bit of ground, so he's gone to a great stable for the type of horse that he was," Arrowfield Stud's Jon Freyer said at the Gold Coast.

"I look forward to him being a Guineas and Derby horse in 18 months' time."

Reflecting on Redoute's Choice, who stood for 19 years at Arrowfield Stud before his death in 2019, Freyer said: "It is the end of an era, really, being the last of the Redoute's Choices. He's been a great servant of the farm and we've been privileged to have stood him for all of these years.

"What a magnificent horse he was both as a stallion and as a personality. He was a great horse for everyone to be around and he'll be missed.

"Now that there's no more of his progeny coming through, it'll hit home more than ever before."

<< *Continued from page 9* At last week's Magic Millions National Broodmare Sale, Freyer signed for eight mares, including race mares Missybeel (Savabeel) (\$800,000) and Scarlet Dream (Sebring) (\$750,000), while Arrowfield acquired Arcadia Queen (Pierro) for \$3.2 million.

"The sales have been fantastic and the broodmare sale last week was spectacular, like nothing I think I have ever seen in all my time. The quality was hard to value and even harder to buy. We were thrilled we finished up with Arcadia Queen and, relative to other things, hopefully she's not that expensive.

"It's testament to both sales companies, really, with the good job they've done to get a buying bench here and to conduct the sales as good as both were."

Meanwhile, Mulcaster and Waller again came to the fore later in the day when the agent went to \$220,000 for a Dundee (High Chaparral) colt offered by Cameron and Kellie Bond of Kenmore Lodge.

The colt is the second live foal out of the Mary-Lou Trivett-owned Quizzed (Oratorio), a three-time winner in Britain and Australia who is a half-sister to European Listed winner Primevere (Singspiel). He was catalogued as Lot 1512.

"He is a nice horse and we thought he was up there with the better horses in the sale and I wasn't surprised he'd make around that figure," Kellie Bond said.

"He was owned by a client who has been with us for quite some time. He was bred on the farm. We kept him back from January even though he was a January quality horse but, being a boutique farm, we held him back as a standout horse for this sale and he delivered, so it was nice."

Bond described yesterday's session as a "selective market" and the "better horses find their way easily but underneath that it's pretty tough going".

"I think quality recommends itself and it's what the market cries out for," she said.

"(The Dundee colt) was a horse by a high-profile stallion, with a nice pedigree and he was a nice individual and a good judge bought him, so it was a nice result."

Quizzed has a weanling filly by No Nay Never (Scat Daddy) and is in foal to Spirit Of Boom (Sequalo).

## Vandyke joins Capitalist bandwagon

David Vandyke saw Capitalist (Written Tycoon) first-hand in the 2016 Golden Slipper and, unfortunately for the now Queensland-based trainer he came off second best, but he has plans for redemption with a second-crop colt by the Newgate Farm-based sire.

The Group 1-winning trainer Vandyke went to \$200,000, his last bid, to buy the Capitalist colt early yesterday.

Consigned by Alexia Fraser Bloodstock as Lot 1437, the colt is out of the dual stakes-winning mare Marquardt (Shamardal) who has had three foals to race for two winners; New Zealander Highfalutin Gal (All Too Hard) and All Stars (All Too Hard).

"I loved the mare. I was really keen to buy one out of a Shamardal mare. She was consistent at stakes level," Vandyke said.

"She had her issues and the two horses out of her, the All Too Hards, have both gone well. The one that raced in New Zealand had a lot of ability but she only had four starts."

Capitalist is already the sire of ATC Champagne Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Captivant and Inglis Millennium (RL, 1200m) winner Profiteer and will challenge for leading first season sire honours and Vandyke was impressed by the make-up of the Marquardt colt.

"He is a very good type and I thought he was one of the nicest colts I have seen here. He looks like a jump-and-run horse, a two-year-old, but then being out of a Shamardal mare, he should race on," he said.

"We will give him the opportunity to race as a two-year-old, but we will be excited to see what he does later on.

"I also have got a bit unfinished business to do because Capitalist beat me half a length in the Slipper. I had Yankee Rose, so I am keen to get vengeance there and hopefully I can do it with this horse. I've now joined the team."

Vandyke also bought a Maurice (Screen Hero) half-brother to the stakes-placed King's Troop (Redoute's Choice) later in the day for \$100,000. Offered by Arrowfield Stud as Lot 1537, the colt is the fifth foal out of Royal Snippets (Royal Academy), a half-sister to Snitzel (Redoute's Choice), Hinchinbrook (Fastnet Rock), Viennese (Redoute's Choice) and Wiener (More Than Ready).

Day two starts at 10am while the Book 2 sale and National Racehorse Sale will take place tomorrow.

## Great Southern Sale pushed back

Inglis has delayed the Great Southern Sale by three weeks with the threat of Covid-19 restrictions severely impacting the Melbourne weanling and broodmare auction if it was to be held as scheduled on Sunday week. Late yesterday, Inglis confirmed the two-day sale at Oaklands Junction would now be held on July 4 and 5. "We are in regular contact with relevant authorities and will continue to be as the situation unfolds," Inglis general manager of bloodstock sales and marketing Sebastian Hutch said. "Our preference is to try and have as many buyers as possible safely attend the sale, in particular interstate visitors, while respecting the desire of vendors to offer their stock in as timely and convenient a fashion as possible. Our hope is that the steps taken by government will see the situation mitigated in the coming days and weeks, as has been the case with other outbreaks in recent months." Supplementary entries for the Great Southern Sale will remain open until 5pm on Monday, June 21.

## Tutukaka out to break maiden in Listed race

Promising juvenile Tutukaka (Tavistock) will be out to break maiden ranks when he contests The Phoenix (Listed, 1500m) at Eagle Farm on Saturday. The gelding has finished runner-up in his two prior starts, including over 1400 metres at the Sunshine Coast last month. "That was a really good run first-up," his trainer Tony Pike said. "That was only his second start and he is a horse that is looking for further, and raceday experience is going to be a huge help to him. He galloped really well in company on the course proper at Eagle Farm and I think he is second favourite for the race in the early market. With natural improvement he should be a chance on Saturday. His main target is the 1800-metre two-year-old race

two weeks later, which he should be extremely hard to beat in." The regally-bred gelding is a half-brother to 14-time Group 1 winner Melody Belle (Commands), and was purchased by Pike out of Haunui Farm's 2020 New Zealand Bloodstock Book 1 Yearling Sale for \$250,000.

## Ryan pair to drop back in class

The prospect of more dry weather in Queensland has forced Nick Ryan to change his plans for both Sirconni (Nicconi) and Mahamedeis (Magnus) with the duo now likely to head to the Ipswich Carnival later this month. Ryan had been aiming the veterans at the Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1400m) and Brisbane Cup (Gr 2, 3200m) but he said yesterday that Sirconni needs a wet track to compete for the Group 1, while Mahamedeis is coming off a "plain" run when finishing ninth of 12 in last Saturday's Premier's Cup (Gr 3, 2400m) on what was his first Queensland start. Sirconni was due to run this Saturday in the Spear Chief Handicap (Listed, 1400m) at Eagle Farm before backing-up into the Stradbroke but Ryan said the weather has forced him into a rethink. "It's looking like there is not much rain so on a good track, he won't be running on Saturday," the trainer told Racing.com. "He'll trial at Doomben next Tuesday and then we'll look to get him to Ipswich and run in the Eye Liner. We really need to do a rain dance with him as Eagle Farm at the moment is just too dry for Sirconni." Regarding Mahamedeis, Ryan said: "It was a bit of a plain run and he tempo didn't suit and he copped a check at the 600 metres, so we've decided to go to Ipswich with him as well and then two weeks to the Caloundra Cup."



## Trooper to tackle Flemington straight

Connections of Brenlyn's Trooper (Redente) are hopeful the three-year-old can add to his tally of three wins from four starts when he gets a first look at the Flemington straight on Saturday. Brenlyn's Trooper was scratched from last Saturday's \$75,000 Benchmark 78 Handicap (1200m) won by The Gauch (Deep Field), with trainer Sylvia Thompson preferring to wait for a \$135,000 three-year-old handicap (1100m) this Saturday at Flemington ahead of the \$140,000 A.R. Creswick Stakes (Listed, 1200m) at the same track on June 19. "He drew a terrible barrier at Caulfield and I thought we'd wait to run him against his own age group," Thompson told Racing.com. "The race on Saturday is great because we get the chance to give him a look at the Flemington straight ahead of the Creswick Stakes. That race has been the plan all along, I think he deserves a go and then we might give him a little break over the winter and bring him back in spring."

## Graham has Kosciuszko in mind for Nicci Trix

Jenny Graham may have another star on her hands as Nicci Trix (Nicconi) aims to book her spot in The Kosciuszko (1200m) with a win in Rosehill's TAB Highway (1100m) on Saturday. The three-year-old has only finished outside of the placings once, when she finished fourth on debut and Graham knew she had a good one on her hands early, with the \$1.3 million The Kosciuszko in her sights for Nicci Trix. "I certainly am looking towards the Kosciuszko. That's one of my targets for her," she said. "She's always shown us quite a lot of ability. We were always thinking of heading towards a Highway race, providing she came through her last run well."

## Bermadez chasing hat-trick

The Mike Moroney-trained Bermadez (Tavistock) will attempt to keep his unbeaten record intact when he runs for the third time at Sandown today. The four-year-old has had his career halted through shoulder problems which Moroney hopes are now behind him. "He's had a couple of problems, one as a younger horse and then on the opposite side

after he won his only start," Moroney said. "You just never know if they will return again, but we've put it down to immaturity and at this stage he's got a lot further than he has at other preparations." Moroney said Bermadez will take his chance from barrier 15 despite being nominated for a race at Flemington on Saturday. "I doubt we'll get a run at Flemington, so we'll head to Sandown on Wednesday and it's a nice progression for him through the grades," Moroney said. "He's still learning his trade. Last time he did a bit wrong when he got to the front but he was probably just a bit better than them. As he's going through his classes, he's going to keep learning a little bit more. He's got a tough draw again with the outside gate, but I think he's improved a bit from that first-up run and we've kept him at 1400 metres, but he seems a horse that will get a bit further down the track." Bermadez was purchased out of Inglewood Stud's 2018 New Zealand Bloodstock Book 1 Yearling Sale draft for \$280,000 by Paul Moroney.

## Wilson set to saddle first city runner

After a successful career in the saddle, Neville Wilson will have his first city runner as a trainer at Sandown when Silkstream (Equiano) steps out in today's Ladbroke It! Handicap (1300m). In 12 starts for Wilson, Silkstream has posted three wins, the latest in a Benchmark 58 race at Warrnambool in March. In two subsequent starts, she has finished second at Terang in April and third at Warrnambool during last month's carnival. "It's a fair way to go, but it's a fillies and mares race at Benchmark 64 level, so it's worth the trip," Wilson said. "But there's a couple in it that go pretty good. Matt Laurie's horse (A Pinch Of Luck) goes alright and supposedly Freedman's horse (Maybe The Best) is pretty smart. But this is a nice race for her and Laura (Lafferty) can take three (kilograms) off her back."

## Capitalist mating on cards for Nettoyer

Nettoyer (Sebring) looks set to have at least one more race before heading to the breeding sheds and a date with Capitalist (Written Tycoon). Bought for \$900,000 at last week's Magic

Millions Broodmare Sale, the dual Group 1 winner was expected to be retired immediately, however Newgate's managing director Henry Field has confirmed she will take her chance in Saturday's Sapphire Stakes (1600m) at Eagle Farm with a run in the Q22 (Gr 2, 2200m) a week later also a possibility.

## Guineas plan for Not An Option

Tony Pike has been left scratching his head after Not An Option's (Not A Single Doubt) performance in the Fred Best Classic (Gr 3, 1400m) at Eagle Farm last Saturday. The colt beat just one runner home in the 1400-metre contest and Pike was duly disappointed with the result. "It was pretty disappointing, especially after his good fresh-up effort," he said. "We are scratching our heads a wee bit. He jumped a lot better on Saturday and got a lovely trip behind Ayrton, he (Nash Rawiller, jockey) said he was travelling very well coming into the corner, but just didn't let go at all. He seems to have pulled up 100 per cent. We will probably barrier trial him in two weeks and then head to the Sunshine Coast Guineas on the third of July."

## Explosive Jack spelled

Triple Derby winner Explosive Jack (Jakkalberry) could have a big spring in store after his pleasing three-year-old season. The Ciaran Maher and David Eustace-trained colt won the Tasmanian Derby (Listed, 2200m), Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) and South Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2500m) before being placed in last Saturday's Queensland Derby (Gr 1, 2400m). He will now head for a well-deserved break before being prepared for Cup targets in the spring. "Saturday was always going to be it, win, lose or draw," Eustace told Racing.com. "We've got a spring plan, which could obviously change, but he'll have three weeks off and then pre-train up there (in Queensland), then head down to Newcastle and spend a little bit of time there at the beach and then Warwick Farm. Ultimately, he'll go Caulfield Cup, Melbourne Cup and have a couple of prep runs leading into that." Explosive Jack was purchased by Moody Racing out of Novara Park's 2019 New Zealand Bloodstock Book 1 Yearling Sale draft for NZ\$100,000.

## Messara aims to unite fractured industry

John Messara AM will attempt to bring Australia's two biggest racing states closer together after being appointed independent chair of Racing Australia. The Arrowfield Stud founder said yesterday that he had undertaken the role for the second time so as to join the forces of Victoria and NSW racing. "The thing that gets me is that here we have in Australia two of the world's most powerful jurisdictions," Messara told RSN927. "They have a common border. How well would our industry go if we could be synergistic? If we could compete to a level but broadly, on the major issues, work together for the good of the game, what a reputation it would give Australia worldwide and these are the things I am aiming to achieve. I think we've got the goodwill of both sides at the moment. I wouldn't have taken the job on unless I believed both sides felt they want to get an outcome out of this. I am looking forward to the challenge. It is probably one of the biggest challenges I've had to undertake. I am dealing with strong individuals on both sides and powerful jurisdictions."

## Walker eyes a return

Michael Walker will meet with doctors tomorrow as he plans the next steps in his recovery from the leg injuries he received in a fall at Pakenham three weeks ago which left him having to undergo surgery three times. "I'm needing crutches now and on Thursday I'll get a hinge brace put on," the rider told Racing.com. "I'm really hopeful that I won't need a knee

reconstruction, but we'll just have to wait and see, that won't happen until after these other injuries have healed anyway. If I don't need a reco, I'm hopeful of being back in the spring but if I do it won't be until the following year."

## Childs planning comeback

Jordan Childs hopes to be back in action early in the new season as he continues to recover from the shoulder injury which has kept him on the sidelines since February. "It's all coming along good now and I'm not too far away from returning to trackwork," Childs told Racing.com. "I'm in no rush to get back to the races, I'm probably going to set myself six weeks once I start riding trackwork again just to get back into the rhythm of things. It's all going to depend on how the shoulder is and eventually go to trials and jump-outs and go from there."

## McDonald appeal to be heard today

James McDonald will face the Racing NSW Appeal Panel today in a bid to ride in Saturday's Queensland Oaks (Gr 1, 2200m) at Eagle Farm. McDonald is looking to have a careless riding ban overturned in order to partner the Chris Waller-trained Grace And Harmony (Sebring) in the \$600,000 contest. McDonald picked up the suspension last Wednesday for his winning ride on the Peter and Paul Snowden-trained Vigorous Flow (Headwater) at Canterbury.

## Bambry hoping to strike early for Kwok

Chrissy Bambry is keen to land some early black type with promising juvenile Bellacontte (Burgundy), who will contest the Castletown Stakes (Listed, 1200m) at Wanganui on Saturday. The filly finished third on debut at Awapuni late last month, but ran home strongly despite showing signs of greenness and Bambry expects the multiple trial winner to benefit from that experience. "I think she will improve quite a bit," she said. "It has come up quite a strong field but you expect that in a stakes race. There are a number of proven horses with wet track form, though I think she should cope with the rain-affected track alright." Bambry

is excited by the prospect of gaining an early result for Hong Kong owner Ben Kwok, who is quickly becoming one of New Zealand's most significant racehorse owners, supporting a vast array of proven and young trainers. "I was lucky that Ben Kwok sent two fillies down last year and she has been through my system the whole way through," the trainer added.

## King accepted into Godolphin Flying Start

New Zealander Charlie King has gained a place on the prestigious Godolphin Flying Start, which commences in Ireland in August. The 21-year-old son of Nick and Anne-Marie King grew up on Brighthill Farm and is a recent graduate of a Bachelor of Commerce at Victoria University, and is currently working for Te Akau Racing. "I'm delighted to be accepted for the programme and to be the first Kiwi for a while," King said. "It's a massive opportunity. The exposure to every aspect of the industry will help make my mind up as to where I'd like to be involved the most and allow me to plan for the future. I was lucky to grow up on a stud farm and be around thoroughbreds as part of our life. We started going to races and sales from a young age and being aware of the industry. I've had an awesome upbringing. I'm super excited. A lot of things happen through luck and people giving me the opportunities and there are a lot of things I'm really grateful for to get a foot in the door. Now it's time to make the most of it and the hard work begins when I'm on the Godolphin Flying Start programme. I'll be making the most of it, learn as much as I can, and take a few strides forward in my career with thoroughbreds."

## Riccarton meeting could be moved

### HK: Noble Desire chasing back-to-back wins

Douglas Whyte is hoping he has found the key to unlocking further success from Noble Desire (Footstepsinthesand) as the gelding bids for back-to-back wins in the first section of this evening's Morrison Handicap (1200m) at Happy Valley today. Outlining race experience and gear tweaks as catalysts for the five-year-old's breakthrough achievement last month, Whyte remains optimistic of the Irish-bred galloper's ability to take another step forward. "He's been knocking at the door for a while now and he just needed to get his head in front at the right time which he did but I think incrementally he's just improved with each run," Whyte said. "He used to be pretty awkward and he would hang in and get his head up but racing's taken its toll on him and he's just got better with every run."

### HK: Purton keen on Beauty Fit

Champion jockey Zac Purton is optimistic of further improvement from Beauty Fit (Ilovethecity) who is looking for successive wins when he contests this evening's Hillier Handicap (1650m) "He can be a bit funny in the gates, he can miss the start - I think going to Happy Valley for the first time under lights and being drawn towards the outside but while there's not much of a crowd there is still a little bit more for him to look at so it's fraught with danger a little bit," Purton said. "But he did everything right last time and if he can break clean then he can possibly settle in the first half of the field and I think that's a good position for him."

### First for Tonalist

Lane's End Farm resident Tonalist (Tapit) sired his first elite-level winner when Country Grammar (4

c ex Arabian Song by Forestry) reversed the form with Royal Ship (Midshipman) in the Hollywood Gold Cup (Gr 1, 10f) at Santa Anita on Monday. The Bob Baffert-trained colt, who had finished a neck behind the runner-up on his most recent outing, scored by a head as favourite with Express Train (Union Rags) another four and a quarter lengths away in third. Tonalist stands in Kentucky for a fee of US\$12,500 (approx. AUD\$16,145).

### Five for Midnight Lute

Midnight Lute (Real Quiet) sire his fifth individual elite level winner when Smooth Like Strait (4 c ex Smooth As Usual by Flower Alley) made all the running to score as favourite in Santa Anita's Shoemaker Mile Stakes (Gr 1, 8f). Placed in Grade 1 company in three of his last four starts, the Michael McCarthy-trained colt made a well deserved breakthrough as he registered the seventh victory of his career with a length-and-a-half success over Say The Word (More Than Ready). Restrainedvengeance (Hold Me Back) was a further length and three-quarters behind in third. Midnight Lute stands at Hill 'n' Dale Farms for US\$15,000 (approx. AUD\$19,375).

### 11 for Exchange Rate

The late Exchange Rate (Danzig) sired his 11th individual elite-level winner when Maxim Rate (5 m ex Catch My Eye by Unbridled's Song) ran out a shock winner of the Gamely Stakes (Gr 1, 9f) on the Santa Anita turf. The Simon Callaghan-trained mare was winning for the sixth time in 16 starts, and fourth in stakes company, when she beat La Signare (Siyouni) and Bodhicitta (Showcasing) by half a length and the same.

### US: More joy for Mo Mosa

Mo Mosa (4 c Uncle Mo - Roughing, by Eskendereya) followed up his last-time-out Listed win with a victory in the Steve Sexton Mile Stakes (Gr 3, 8f) at Lone Star Park on Monday. Trained by Mike Maker, the colt

was winning for the fourth time in 16 starts. Favourite C Z Rocket (City Zip) finished three and a half lengths behind the winner in second, with another half a length back to Silver Prospector (Declaration Of War) in third.

### IRE: Pondus faces nine

The Lloyd Williams-owned Pondus (Sea The Moon) will have his second start since finishing second behind True Self (Oscar) in the Queen Elizabeth Stakes (Gr 3, 2600m) at Flemington in November when he lines up in the Race To The Ebor Handicap (1m 6f) at the Curragh tonight. The Joseph O'Brien-trained five-year-old, who finished down the field in Group 3 contest at the Curragh on his most recent outing, faces nine rivals including the OTI Racing-owned Camphor (Camelot).

### UK: Love set to bypass Coronation Cup

Last season's runaway Epsom Oaks (Gr 1, 1m 4f) winner Love (Galileo) looks set to bypass a return to that same track in Friday's Coronation Cup (Gr 1, 1m 4f) and instead make her eagerly anticipated seasonal debut in the Prince Of Wales's Stakes (Gr 1, 1m 2f) at Royal Ascot. Despite the absence of the dual Classic winner, Aidan O'Brien is still set to send out a strong challenge in the shape of full brothers Japan (Galileo) and Mogul.

### FRA: O'Brien could run two in Derby

St Mark's Basilica (Siyouni), winner of the Poule d'Essai des Poulains (Gr 1, 1600m), is on course to attempt to complete a French Classic double in the Prix de Jockey Club (Gr 1, 2100m) at Longchamp on Saturday. The Aidan O'Brien-trained colt could be joined in the race by his stablemate Van Gogh (American Pharoah), who also has the option of running in the previous day's Epsom Derby (Gr 1, 1m 4f).

## Golden Sixty awaits as Sky Darci enhances the Hong Kong Derby form

Caspar Fownes is looking ahead to a big-race campaign for Sky Darci (Darci Brahma) next season when his talented four-year-old will have the chance to take on Golden Sixty (Medaglia D'Oro) in what would be a desirable clash between the last two Hong Kong Derby (Listed, 2000m) winners, possibly in December's Hong Kong Mile (Gr 1, 1600m).

"I'm not afraid of taking on any horse. We've beaten the champs when they were in their prime with our horses before, so why not go out and knock another champion off, that's what we're here to do," Fownes told Asia Bloodstock News in the wake of reports suggesting he might plot a campaign next term that would see his stable hero swerve Hong Kong's current superstar.

"No, not at all," he continued. "It's just that Sky Darci's the type of horse that I can train differently and I can sprint him, that's all. It depends on which way I want to go and I'll make that decision early next season. It depends on his rating and we'll see what is around but there's every chance he'll start off in the Premier Bowl over 1200 metres.

"With another six months under his belt, he's not going to be too far away. Joao (Moreira) feels he's an international horse, he believes he can fight with the champ. We'll train him the way that's best suited to get a winning result, whether that's the 1200 or the mile: probably the mile the way things are going but we'll train him according to the programme and take it each race at a time."

Sky Darci's victory in last Sunday's Lion Rock Trophy Handicap (Gr 3, 1600m), in



which he held off Derby fifth and Classic Cup (Listed, 1800m) winner Healthy Happy (Zoustar), pushed the Derby form back into the spotlight just an hour or so before Shahryar (Deep Impact) took the Japanese equivalent with a thrilling late rush that denied Efforia (Epiphaneia) a triple crown shot, and six days out from the English original.

Every major Derby, be it at Epsom, Fuchu or Sha Tin, is pored over. The form gurus and the casual observers alike will scrutinise the outcome as soon as the winner has passed the post, such is a Derby's importance to the industry and its fascinating status as a barometer of any given Classic generation's quality. The rash observers will readily form fixed opinions while the wise will wait to see how the contenders stack up in future assignments before declaring the crop good, bad or somewhere in between.

Hong Kong's racing has not had much depth to its quality this season as the old stagers have declined and the younger replacements have been slow to emerge, but Sky Darci and Healthy Happy leading home their elders provided the second positive outcome for Hong Kong's Classic Series form in the space of seven

days, following Derby third Panfield's (Lookin' At Lucky) Champions & Chater Cup (Gr 1, 2400m) win in open grade.

"They say every year that they're no good," Fownes continued. "I think we'll see some good horses come out of our Derby this year. The best of the four-year-olds, two or three of them will get a 115 rating and above, which is pretty good. You can't complain about that."

On the flip side, Sky Darci and Healthy Happy carried light imposts under handicap conditions, with the Derby winner in receipt of a helpful 18lb from top-weight Ka Ying Star (Cityscape), who finished sixth in the small field of seven. And, while Panfield's trainer Tony Millard echoed Fownes' take on the Derby form, he also acknowledged the landscape in which the current four-year-olds find themselves.

"The four-year-olds are looking pretty good," Millard noted. "Saying that, we have a huge amount of older horses that are past their best, but still, these horses have stepped up. It's not like last year when they had the one horse and the rest were pretty ordinary. It's a bit refreshing that we have at least two of them that are OK."



The 2020 Hong Kong Derby was all about Golden Sixty, who has gone on to rattle off a further seven wins without defeat, including four that carry Group 1 designation. Francis Lui's champion was rested after the Derby for the remainder of that season, so by the end of May last year, ten Derby horses had raced a further 19 times for no win, while this year at the same juncture, 11 Derby runners out of the 2021 edition have posted two wins from 17 subsequent starts.

While Golden Sixty has marched on imperiously, the 2020 Derby also-rans have to date notched only seven wins between them from 128 attempts, although Columbus County (Redwood) and More Than This (Dutch Art) both have managed Group 1 placings.

Golden Sixty's rider Vincent Ho respects Sky Darci and his peers but nonetheless maintains a firm faith in his mount who, unlike the rising generation, is proven in set-weight Group 1 races against international opposition.

"If these four-year-olds mature more they'll be competitive next season," Ho said. "Some nice horses like Sky Darci are coming out of this year's Derby but we'll still have to see how they get on when they come to set weights and compete with the big boys because that's a different story."

Ho is pleased that Golden Sixty is safely in his stable resting ahead of next season, with connections having opted not to attempt to complete the Hong Kong Triple Crown in the Champions & Chater Cup. That would have entailed stretching well beyond the gelding's optimum distance, having landed the first two legs, the Stewards' Cup (Gr 1, 1600m) and Hong Kong Gold Cup (Gr 1, 2000m) prior to his win in the Champions Mile at the end of April.

"It's challenging going from the Champions Mile up to a mile and a half within a month, and it's not like we had planned it out from early this season; he'd already had seven runs, and the last couple of races were a bit tough. He recovered really fast from the Champions Mile last time but before that, the Gold Cup over 2000 metres, it took him about a week to get back to normal," Ho added.

Millard knows the difficulty of trying to win the Triple Crown, which has only been accomplished once, by River Verdon in 1994. Panfield was the South African's first

Champions & Chater Cup success but he had attempted to pull off the three-race challenge with his outstanding Hong Kong champion Ambitious Dragon (Pins) in 2012, only to see the gelding finish second in the final leg.

"Ambitious Dragon was just phenomenal and he had the stamina on his female line, whereas Golden Sixty, it's his brilliance that got him the 2000 metres," Millard observed. "There's not a hell of a lot around at the moment in that bracket that can knock you back, you've got has-beens and never-wases here at the 2000 metres and that's why he's seen the 2000 metres. Somebody has got to win."

"But I think they were clever not to go to the 2400 metres. He'd have got hammered because they didn't mess around like they did in the Queen Mother Memorial Cup. A race like that could have done him and he might not have come back. It takes a special horse, that's why the Triple Crown hasn't been won for so long."

By missing the Champions & Chater Cup, Ho hopes he will have a horse to go to war with on the international scene next season, quarantine and travel regulations permitting.

"We're actually looking for overseas races next season and I also discussed this with Francis because if we want to race him, we'd better have time off now and plan for next season, select some races and see which one suits him. I think it will be good for him to travel," the jockey said.

Fownes, as ever, would like to test Sky Darci on foreign tracks too but is not getting ahead of himself, with Hong Kong still requiring a three-week quarantine for travellers returning to the city.

"I've never been scared to travel," he said, "but we live in a world where we don't know what's going on day to day. If it opens in the next six to 12 months without restrictions, which looks doubtful, then we can make plans. Until that happens, you have to stay put, shop around in your backyard and see what you can get."

The last Hong Kong Derby winner to venture offshore was the 2016 victor Werther (Tavistock) who went close in the 2018 Takarazuka Kinen (Gr 1, 2200m) at Hanshin. But a combination of the Hong Kong Jockey Club being keen to see its best horses remain at home and protect the ratings of its own major races, and the preferences of owners often fearful of past failures, meant that those excursions were tempered.

Even before Covid-19, the city's recent champions Beauty Generation (Road To Rock) and Exultant (Teofilo) were grounded. Once restrictions do lift, Hong Kong's horses will probably be free to go to Dubai and Japan, even Australia and Britain, and rattle a few cages again. And that would be the best possible advert for the merits of Hong Kong's Derby form.
