Small-time player Sousa enjoys success at Tattersalls with trusted partners

Russian Camilla makes 300,000 guineas in astute trade by Australia-based syndicate

o many, Roger Sousa may not be a recognisable name, but his growing Platinum Breeding and Racing operation has already made an impact in bloodstock circles and the Sydneysider has big plans for that to continue.

Sousa has experienced the ultimate success with Brave Smash (Tosen Phantom), a twoyear-old stakes winner in Japan who won a Futurity Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) and Manikato Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) in Australia, and has has breeding interests in 2014 Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) winner Protectionist (Monsun).

On Tuesday night, the owner and breeder also enjoyed a big return on his investment in Russian Camilla (Camelot), the sister to Australia's northern hemisphere-bred dual Group 1 winner Russian Camelot, who made 300,000gns (approx. AUD\$571,000) at the Tattersalls December Mare Sale in the UK. *Continued on page 2>>*

"The whole team set the alarm and we were watching the sale eagerly," Sousa said yesterday.

"We had a lot of interest leading up to the sale and, after her first race when she did so well, we knew that we were onto a good thing.

"We were just so happy and we couldn't wish for anything better. It all just panned out."

Russian Camilla, who unleashed a startling finish to score an unlikely victory at Kempton in November for trainer Sylvester Kirk, was bought by Oceanic Bloodstock's Michel Zerolo on behalf of Peter Brant's White Birch

Farm.

Lambourn stables by McKeever on Boxing Day last year, came under notice from agents and owners in both hemispheres after her last-to-first Kempton win last month, but the partnership elected to sell her publicly.

"It is the sort of thing where you're damned if you do and damned if you don't as you just never know what can happen at a public auction," Sousa said.

"We did knock back some offers prior to the auction, but we knew we had the right product and were ticking the right boxes. *Continued on page 4>>*

<< *Continued from page 2* "We were fairly confident and it was just a matter of how much someone was going to pay."

Sousa's Platinum Breeding and Racing currently has about ten mares and foals as well as another ten yearlings heading to the 2021 sales around the country. He considers his partners Mee and Evans, and McKeever in Russian Camilla's instance, as close friends as well as trusted advisers and believes that is part of his success.

"We have a team where everyone knows their role. Shannon does the form work and analyses the sectionals and all those sorts of things," he said.

"He generally identifies them and then the process starts from there. I have confidence in the team and I don't need much convincing if the numbers are there and everything works in our favour, I am confident to go ahead with it because I trust these guys."

While Sousa, who established his own real estate agency aged just 19 before selling it and turning to financial planning, enjoys his relative anonymity in racing and breeding circles, he does have aspirations to increase his level of involvement, albeit gradually.

"At the moment, people obviously don't know me and that's fine - there's a lot of people I don't know either as our paths haven't crossed yet, but there's room for everyone," he said, describing himself as a 'small player.

"You can be small, medium or big. It's an exciting industry. You're going to have your ups and downs, but it's a matter of also being there for the long-term by not going in too heavy at the start and letting it play out smoothly by being a bit diversified with your stock."

He added: "It's about patience and meeting the right people and being around the right people for guidance. We have a system in place and we all abide by it and we trust each other's judgment.

two for 700,000gns (approx. AUD\$1,330,300). The five-year-old mare, who won eight of her 18 starts in Australia, was offered in foal to Kingman (Invincible Spirit) by Genesis Green Stud.

Also, Tashaarok (Invincible Spirit), who was being offered in foal to Night Of Thunder (Dubawi) to southern hemisphere time, was also passed in by vendor Tinnakill House for 100,000gns (approx. AUD\$190,000).

Rosemont Stud, who last week went to \$410,000 to secure Small Minds (Canny Lad) out of the Inglis Digital November (Late) Online auction, bought Promise Of Success (Dansili) for 27,000gns (approx. AUD\$51,500) at Tattersalls on Tuesday.

Purchased in conjunction with David Redvers Bloodstock, the placed four-year-old is out of a winning daughter of Newbury Listed scorer Measured Tempo (Sadler's Wells) from the family of Prix du Jockey Club (Gr 1, 2400m) victor Anabaa Blue (Anabaa).

The Gnarwarre-based farm had also been active during Monday's opening session, landing

Marietta Robusti (Equiano) with a bid of 49,000gns (approx. AUD\$93,000).

The five-year-old, a five-time winner, is a half-sister to the Listed winner and Group 2-placed Three Sea Captains (Choisir) as well as the dam of this year's Molecomb Stakes (Gr 3, 5f) scorer Steel Bull (Clodovil).

Respected New Zealand agent Paul Willetts also got a piece of Tuesday's action when he went to 65,000gns (approx. AUD\$123,500) to secure the winning Frankel (Galileo) five-year-old Sing A Rainbow.

A half-sister to Sandown Group 3 winner and Group 1-performed Lavender's Blue (Sea The Stars), Sing A Rainbow is out of Prix Chloe (Gr 3, 1800m) winner Beatrice Aurore (Danehill Dancer).

Harrison backing Gemma judgment

David Harrison is confident Gemma's Son (Snippetson) will see out the Kingston Town Classic (Gr 1, 1800m) trip at Ascot on Saturday as the three-year-old competes over further than a mile for the first time. Gemma's Son began his preparation with two 1000-metre runs before being stepped up in trip for the Belgravia Stakes (Listed, 1200m), then again for the Lee Steere Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) and again for the WA Guineas (Gr 2, 1600m) last time out. Despite Gemma's Son showing blistering speed over sprinting trips as a juvenile, in which he won his first four starts between 1000 and 1200 metres, and having not yet placed over further than 1200 metres, Harrison believes he will succeed over longer distances. "With his weight, barrier and the record of three-year-olds in the race, I'm certain he will be competitive," Harrison told The Races WA. "The last two furlongs of his previous two races have been his strongest this preparation. I have no doubt he will run out a strong 1800 metres now that he can settle in his races. From the barrier he can get a soft run. I decided to go the Kingston Town path after the Belgravia. He was just becoming a chopping block out in front in earlier races."

Chapter And Verse chasing second George Moore

The Desleigh Forster-trained Chapter And Verse (Rothesay) will bid for a second George Moore Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) success at Doomben on Saturday. The six-year-old gelding, who was last seen finishing sixth in the Spear Chief (Listed, 1350m) in June, has not won since narrowly landing this contest 12 months ago, but Forster is confident he can run well. "He's going into this race first-up because it's a suitable race for him," Forster said. "He's going as good as ever and is doing everything right. I want to get through this race first before deciding where he'll run next but the Magic Millions is his goal." The Tony Gollan-trained Jonker (Spirit Of Boom) looks to be the horse to beat as Gollan chases his fourth win in the summer feature.

Creedence on course for Pakenham Cup

Matt Cumani will bid for back-to-back Pakenham Cup (Listed, 2500m) successes on Saturday, with Creedence (Helmet) aiming to match Etah James' (Raise The Flag) 60-1 upset last year. Creedence finished eighth in last year's contest when prepared by Lindsay Park, but has been rejuvenated since joining Cumani in the middle of the year, finishing sixth in the Bart Cummings (Gr 3, 2510m) and Geelong Cup (Gr 3, 2400m) and fourth in the Queen Elizabeth Stakes (Gr 3, 2600m) at Flemington. "He's probably just below the top class and that's why I diverted from the Lexus to the Queen Elizabeth," Cumani said. "He's a nice, tough stayer who should be suited in a race like the Pakenham Cup, which will be slightly easier."

Jenni ready for Pakenham test

In other Pakenham Cup news, the David Brideoake-trained Princess Jenni (High Chaparral) will line-up in the \$300,000 feature, with the last-start Bendigo Cup (Gr 3, 2400m) winner having recovered from a foot abscess in time to take her chance. "The foot abscess meant she couldn't run in the Zipping Classic, which was a bit of a nuisance, but we've pressed on and she's coming into this race fresh and in good shape," Brideoake told Racing.com. Princess Jenni, a winner of six of her 19 outings, will once again be partnered by Jye McNeil on Saturday and Brideoake added: "Jye rode her so well at Bendigo and it's nice to have his services again as he's really taken giant steps in his career." Princess Jenni will shoulder 61 kilograms in the Pakenham Cup and she has drawn barrier ten.

Ellsberg on trial for Magic Millions trip

A start in the Magic Millions Guineas (RL, 1400m) will be on the line for promising threeyear-old Ellsberg (Spill The Beans) when he lines up in a 1500-metre Benchmark 72 at Rosehill on Saturday. After winning on debut at Warwick Farm last month, Ellsberg has notched successive placings, including a third in the Spring Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m) at Newcastle, and co-trainer Gerald Ryan says he needs to win to book his passage to the Gold Coast. "He is a Magic Millions horse, whether he goes there or not we'll decide after Saturday," Ryan, who trains in partnership with Sterling Alexiou, said. "But he would have to win on Saturday to get in. He has always shown me ability and he's been given time." Ellsberg is majority-owned by Aquis Farm, home of Ellsberg's sire Spill The Beans (Snitzel) prior to his premature death last year after a promising start at stud.

Vancouver filly impresses at Sandown

Vandoula Lass (Vancouver) made a promising start to her racing career when taking out the Clanbrooke Racing Handicap (1000m) at Sandown yesterday for Hawkes Racing. The two-year-old filly defeated Godolphin's Morning Briefing - Sponsored by Woodside Park Stud

Translation (Frosted) by two and threequarter lengths, prompting praise from Wayne Hawkes and rider Craig Williams. "We did think she'd come here and win," Hawkes told Racing.com. "She's an absolute dream (to work with), she walked into the mounting enclosure and walked around as if she owned the joint and looked like a five-year-old gelding. It's always good when a two-year-old has got ability but they've also got the attitude." Williams, who rode Vandoula Lass when she won an 800-metre Flemington jumpout on November 20, added: "I was so impressed by her physique but more importantly her mannerisms in the jumpout. They had two options with races and they found the weakest race to give her the great experience. She's a real high-class filly with a great attitude. For a two-year-old filly at the end of this year leading into next year she's a really exciting filly that I think they'll have no problem getting out to 1200 metres or further later (in her career)."

Rare Hare also wins first start

Rare Hare (Reliable Man) was another to impress at Sandown vesterday with victory in the three-year-old maiden over 1300 metres. Purchased by Michael Kent Jr for just NZ\$25,000 at last year's NZB Ready To Run Sale, Rare Hare looks a promising acquisition after defeating Ord (Written Tycoon) by a short-head, with the pair two and a half lengths clear of third-placed Fan Club (Pins). "He's got an immature body and we wanted to look after him down there (at their Warrnambool stable)," Kent Jr, who trains in partnership with Mick Price, told Racing. com. "I picked this race out three weeks ago but I didn't think it would come up this strong; the form around Ord is exceptional. He's a lovely horse going forward, it's really exciting." Rare Hare is by Reliable Man (Dalakhani) out of Danehill (Danzig) mare Chuckle, who won two races including the Dark Jewel Classic (Listed, 1400m) at Scone. Chuckle has produced Listed winner Hoofit (Mossman), as well as 2017 Villiers Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m) winner Crack Me Up (Mossman).

Kent Jr outlines autumn plans

Kent Jr yesterday announced the autumn plans for Thousand Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Odeum (Written Tycoon) and Atlantic Jewel Stakes (Listed, 1200m) scorer Night Raid (Vancouver). The former, who finished a narrow second to Shout The Bar (Not A Single Doubt) in the Empire Rose Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) last time out, will be put on a path towards the Australasian Oaks (Gr 1, 2000m), while Night Raid will resume in the Typhoon Tracy Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) in February. "Odeum has thrived (since spelling). She's improved in the paddock, she looks enormous," Kent Jr told Racing.com. "She's going to start work early next month and kick off in the Kewney at Flemington. That's the rough plan. Shamus Mills, the managing owner, has indicated he wants to have a go at the Australasian Oaks. He wants to find out (if she can get 2000 metres)." On Night Raid, Kent Jr added: "She's a stakes-winning filly and we are going to keep her to sprint trips. The rough plan with her is to kick her off in the Typhoon Tracy. And work around those stakes races with her. Her mother (Raid) was a Group 1-placed sprinter and that's what we think will be best for her."

Kennedy Racing's Al Maher filly dominates

Arabian Hussey (Al Maher), the most expensive Al Maher (Danehill) filly sold last year, pulverised the field in a 1400-metre Benchmark 64 handicap at Sandown yesterday. Purchased by Sheamus Mills and James Kennedy for \$190,000 from the Edinglassie Stud draft at last year's Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale, the Caroline Jennings-trained filly defeated Chequerboard (Fastnet Rock) by five lengths, making it two wins from four starts. "She just blew them away today, she might be special," said winning rider Arron Lynch. "She was strong right through the line, there was still plenty underneath me." Arabian Hussey is a half-sister to stakes-winner Kobayashi (I Am Invincible) and is the third winner from three foals to race from Woodstock Hussey (Hussonet). Edinglassie will present the current yearling from Woodstock Hussey, a colt by Epaulette (Commands), at Magic Millions in January as Lot 955.

Flemington to welcome back crowds

Flemington will welcome a crowd of 500 to its next meeting on December 12 as Victoria Racing Club confirmed members and owners will be allowed back on track. VRC are hoping to increase that to 5,000 for subsequent meetings, although that will require a change to current Victorian government guidelines. "We can't wait to welcome a crowd of 500 for Living Legends race day on Saturday, December 12, our first crowd of any size since 'Super Saturday' in March," VRC chief executive Steve Rosich said. "Race days haven't been the same without our members, owners and racing fans. They create the atmosphere that contributes so much to our sport. We hope that, subject to approval from the Victorian government, we will be able to significantly increase the crowd size to 5,000 people on December 19 and an even greater capacity in January, beginning with our popular New Year's Day race day."

All-Star Mile the target for **2019 winner Mystic Journey**

Inaugural All-Star Mile (1600m) winner Mystic Journey (Needs Further) was the first horse nominated for next year's contest, as Adam Trinder lines the five-year-old up for a bid to regain the crown she won in 2019. "That's (the All-Star Mile) the plan of attack with her," Trinder told Racing.com. "She's back in training for ten days now. She will kick off in the back end of January in the Ladbrokes Stakes, a weight-for-age 1200-metre (race) here in Tassie. Then we will move forward to the All-Star Mile, if she can gain the votes. We will just assess off the back of her first run whether she totally preps in Tassie...or whether she looks to head to a Futurity in February. We will get more clarity throughout the month of January, I would suggest."

San Huberto to remain with Cumani

San Huberto (Speightstown), who ran third in the Sandown Cup (Listed, 3200m) on November 14 as part of a two-start spring campaign, will remain in Australia under the care of Matt Cumani. The northern hemisphere-bred fouryear-old, who landed the Prix Vicomtesse

Vigier (Gr 2, 3000m) at Chantilly in June when under the care of Fabrice Chappet, will be targeted at races over middle distances, rather than staying trips, in the autumn. "We're going to give San Huberto the sort of preparation that many of these European staying types have had after their first Melbourne Cup campaign," Terry Henderson, managing director of owners OTI Racing, told Racing.com. "His initial target will be the Australian Cup as he seems to have shown us enough speed to head towards that race. We've seen it in the past through horses like Manighar, Hug's Dancer, Spillway and Harlem that those sorts of horses, the way Australians tend to train, they put a bit of speed into them. So we'll most likely start him off in the Peter Young Stakes then go to the Australian Cup prior to going to Sydney. His participation in Sydney is dependent on the weather because he is a top-of-the-ground horse, so if we didn't go to Sydney he'd remain in Melbourne and target the Andrew Ramsden Stakes."

Achernar Star retired

Achernar Star (Gingerbread Man) has been retired following his fifth-place finish in the Toorak Handicap (Gr 1, 1600m) at Caulfield in October. Achernar Star, whose career highlights include Listed wins in Bunbury Stakes (1400m) and Grandstand Cup (1500m) and a third in the 2017 Kingston Town Classic (Gr 1, 1800m), has not won since March 2019. Amelia Park's managing part-owner Peter Walsh said the decision to retire Achernar Star was an easy one. "He had joint issues and we could have given him a few months off to see how he goes, but it was the right time to retire him," Walsh told The Races WA. "He has been a very good horse for us and he can now come back home and we will look after him. He ran a lot of seconds, but he was ultra-consistent and always put in. He was a tough horse who ran a lot of good races and was the first to win over a million dollars for me."

RV to work on standardised deductions

Racing Victoria says it is working with wagering service providers to achieve standardised reductions for horses that are scratched. Speaking on After The Last's The Agenda: Wagering, RV's CFO/CCO Aaron Morrison said: "We are really keen to take a leadership role on deductions. It's frustrating as a punter. We have already done some work. We have already started consulting with wagering operators and I think they're supportive of a standardised system." Morrison also said work would be done modifying the race fields legislation to have those rules set in stone. "We've got the ability to do that," he added. "Operators would have to make some technical changes to their systems, but we are working through those issues with them and confident that we can look at something in the coming months."

Apprentice Griffiths joins Snowdens

Brandon Griffiths will join the Peter and Paul Snowden stable on Monday having been based at Randwick with retiring trainer Pat Webster for the last 12 months. The 23-year-old apprentice acknowledges Webster as being instrumental in his development and is excited to familiarise himself with his new surroundings. "We called Peter on Monday and asked if he'd be interested in taking me on and he said to give him a day to think about it," Griffiths told Racing NSW. "I called him (Tuesday) morning and he said to come into his office. I walked over to the office and I was just sweating all the way there, dreading if he was going to say no. It was very intimidating until I got to sit down and talk to him and we got chatting for a good half an hour or 40 minutes. I'm just excited to get stuck into it on Monday morning. When Mr Webster picked me up and brought me to Randwick this is always what he thought his goal was, to get me as far as he could in prepping me for a big move like this one. Now that he's retiring and we've been accepted into the Snowden camp he feels proud and relieved."

Frank Cleary fined

Racing NSW stewards have fined Frank Cleary \$3,500 after prohibited substance dexamethasone was present in a pre-race urine sample taken from My Boy Lubby (Eurozone) before he finished ninth in a 2000-metre contest at Wagga Wagga on September 19. Cleary pleaded guilty to the charge.

NZB Ready to Run Sale results released

The final results have been released for the 2020 NZB Ready to Run Sale, held last month on November 18 and 19. A total of 198 twoyear-olds were sold for turnover of \$18,226,500. The average reached \$92,053 while the median settled at \$55,000. A number of sales were actioned after the auction, which has seen the clearance rate climb to a breakthrough 83 per cent. The highlight of the week was the record-breaking \$700,000 purchase by Te Akau Racing principal David Ellis through Lot 298, a Savabeel (Zabeel) colt out of Miss Opulence (O'Reilly), offered on account of Sam and Hana Beatson's Riversley Park. Riversley Park also secured the leading vendor by aggregate title for the fourth consecutive year, selling 23 horses for a total turnover of \$4,152,500. This year's sale was conducted in unprecedented circumstances, with international clients unable to be present during on-farm parade inspections or on the grounds at the Karaka Sales Centre. "While the Ready to Run Sale gave us an opportunity to unveil our new online bidding platform, it also enabled us to see our groundwork and preparation unfold in the auction ring," said NZB bloodstock sales manager Danny Rolston. "We had a large number of international buyers active on the platform, accounting for 31 per cent of the total turnover. Our New Zealand-based agents were also incredibly busy inspecting and purchasing on behalf of their clients on the grounds, while our vendors did their part providing as much transparent information as possible for the buyers. It was certainly great to see everyone rewarded for their efforts during what has been an unpredictable year."

James and Wellwood pair in 'peak form'

Roger James and Robert Wellwood are set to be double handed in Saturday's Captain Cook Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) at Trentham courtesy of Hypnos (Reliable Man) and Concert Hall (Savabeel). The former was last seen winning the Coupland's Bakeries Mile (Gr 2, 1600m) by one and a half lengths having taken out

the Spring Sprint Handicap (Gr 3, 1400m) on October 17, while Concert Hall scored in the Tauranga Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m) on November 14 having landed the Thompson Handicap (Gr 3, 1600m) three weeks earlier. Both have been the subject of an upbeat bulletin by James. "All we can do is be happy with what we are sending into the race and I think they have both had great preparations - they've had patient careers and they are both in career peak form," he said. "It's a big mile down there. Concert Hall has been down there twice and won on both occasions over the distance. I'm confident we can get another good mile out of her." Of Hypnos, he added: "He's come back tremendously really. I expect a good run but know that Group 1s are never easy to win."

Cheaperthandivorce is a keeper

James and Wellwood unleashed a potential Group 1 star of the future when well-related three-year-old Cheaperthandivorce (Savabeel) made the perfect start to her racing career at Rotorua yesterday. The Trelawney Stud homebred is the only filly out of New Zealand Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) heroine Boundless (Van Nistelrooy) and she built on the promise of her recent trial second behind subsequent winner Explosively (Sweynesse) when taking out the TW Moore 1400 under Vinnie Colgan. "We were pleased with her trial leading into the race," Wellwood said. "The fact that the horse that beat her came out and won at Te Rapa gave us a bit of confidence. It was still impressive to see her perform so professionally on Wednesday and see her put them away so easily."

In-form Sharrock out to continue good run

Allan Sharrock, who has saddled an impressive 19 winners from 84 starters so far this season, will be out to continue his good recent run when he is represented by nine runners at his local track New Plymouth today before unleashing a further two runners at Trentham on Saturday. "I would say the best of mine at New Plymouth is Reliable Miss, she is going pretty well. She came from the back in a walking race last start, running the best sectionals and she was a bit tubby. I think she will be hard to beat," Sharrock said. Of his five debutants at the meeting, Sharrock added: "I don't mind Alhambra Lad and the Proisirs are going well. He is out of a Montjeu mare and is a big, powerful horse. He has worked up quite well and would like better ground." Looking ahead to Saturday, where the Trentham track is rated a Heavy10 following a deluge earlier in the week, Sharrock will saddle impressive last-start winner Justaskme (No Excuse Needed), a winner of four of his seven outings. "He is very progressive," Sharrock said. "Off ground doesn't worry him and he has come through his most recent run jumping out of his skin. He will have this run and then we will put him aside. He is going to be a very nice horse for the autumn."

HK: McEvoy relinquishes Classique Legend ride

Kerrin McEvoy will not ride Classique Legend (Not A Single Doubt) in next Sunday's Hong Kong Sprint (Gr 1, 1200m) due to the ongoing uncertainty over international travel. McEvoy has been the five-year-old's regular partner in Australia and was on board when Classique Legend produced a devastating turn of foot to win The Everest (1200m) by two and a half lengths in October. However, McEvoy said yesterday: "With the uncertainty on travel back to Australia, I've decided to forgo my ride on Classique Legend in Hong Kong next Sunday." Vincent Ho, who partnered Classique Legend to a third-place finish in a Sha Tin barrier trial on Tuesday, is expected to take the mount.

15 for Belardo

Haunui Farm shuttler Belardo (Lope De Vega) sired his 15th individual winner yesterday when Desert Boots (2 g ex City Chic by Street Cry) got off the mark at the fourth time of asking in the sevenfurlong nursery at Lingfield. Trained by Mark Johnston, the juvenile showed a good attitude in the closing stages of a messy race to fend off the challenge of Cuban Cigar (Havana Gold) by a neck, with a further one and a quarter lengths back to Decadent (Mehmas) in third. Belardo, who will have his first southern hemisphere twoyear-olds this season, has already produced five stakes winners in the northern hemisphere, with Rockfel Stakes (Gr 2, 7f) scorer Isabella Giles the pick of the bunch. Darley recently announced the son of Lope De Vega (Shamardal) will stand at Kildangan Stud in Ireland for an unchanged fee of \in 10,000 (approx. AUD\$16,150) in 2021.

UK: Hollie Doyle nominated for Sports Personality of the Year

Hollie Doyle's memorable year could be capped off with victory in the most prestigious award in British sport after it was announced on Tuesday that she has been shortlisted for BBC Sports Personality of Year 2020. The trailblazing jockey has enjoyed a historic campaign, being crowned Sunday Times Sportswoman of the Year last week, and she has joined just five other sportspeople, including Lewis Hamilton and Stuart Broad, in being nominated for Sports Personality of the Year. Doyle will also participate in the International Jockeys' Championship at Happy Valley on Wednesday where she will vie for the most lucrative jockeys' challenge winner's cheque in the world - a prize of HKD\$500,000. Among the international competition is her partner and fellow leading rider Tom Marquand. "Tom and I are really looking forward to going to Hong Kong," Doyle said. "It is a place we have always thought about going to and the opportunity has now arisen so we are excited about the prospect. It is a great opportunity to ride in Hong Kong at the end of a great year. This year has been crazy really for the both of us. It could not have gone much better. We are really grateful and pleased with the way it has gone. We are already looking forward to next year and it would be fantastic to have even more success."

ometimes in breeding and racing you're rewarded for your own judgement. Sometimes other people's decisions work for you. The latter is the case concerning former WA Supreme Court judge Robert Anderson and Elite

Street, who completed an undulating journey in rising from fourth in a Pinjarra maiden six months ago to becoming a Group 1 winner in Saturday's Winterbottom Stakes at Ascot.

The four-year-old gelding is the third toplevel victor under the banner of Anderson and wife Ann's Anita Vale Stud. The first two came judiciously, with the Andersons breeding triple Group 1 winner Scenic Shot and 2003 Salinger Stakes winner Ancient Song. The third arrived fortuitously, through their purchase of a nineyear-old mare named Elite Ateates while she was carrying her first foal - a Street Boss chesnut who would become Elite Street.

"We did get a bit lucky. Sometimes it works that way," says Anderson, 80, as excited as he's ever been in 40 years in breeding.

Anderson was urged to buy Elite Ateates in 2016 by bloodstock agent Damon Gabbedy of Belmont Bloodstock Agency. The price-tag of \$65,000 was more than Anderson was planning for a new mare, but Gabbedy delivered a convincing argument which ultimately swayed the judge.

Elite Ateates was no champion on the track, with five wins from 24 starts, though one was in city class at Eagle Farm. But those wins - from 850 metres to 1100 metres - did speak of an abundance of dash in a rich pedigree (which has just grown substantially richer).

She's by Exceed And Excel - both a champion speed sire and an outstanding

broodmare producer - out of the former flyer Ateates. That Gary Portelli-trained mare was the winner of four Group 2s over 1200 metres, the last being the 2002 Expressway Stakes at Warwick Farm, and was third in a Goodwood Handicap, for a very healthy-back-then \$650,000 in prize-money.

Ateates was by the blistering Zeditave, who, in a delicious piece of symmetry considering Anderson's later involvement in her descendant, was by The Judge.

"Damon strongly recommended that we buy Elite Ateates," Anderson says. "We had a good look at her pedigree, and it looked good. We very much liked the cross of Street Cry (sire of Street Boss, Winx, and many more) over Exceed And Excel. We just love the Street Cry line, and it did look a very strong mix."

Still, not only does Anita Vale have an accent on quality over quantity - the Andersons own just seven broodmares - they mostly breed to sell. Here came the turn of another friendly card.

"We entered Elite Street for the (2018) Magic Millions Yearling Sale in Perth but his x-rays showed he had a chip in one knee and that the other knee looked like it was about to produce a chip. So we withdrew him and decided to keep him ourselves," says Anderson.

The horse would compete under the racing partnership between Anita Park and trainer Dan Morton's parents, Len and Annette. Corrective surgery and a long spell followed, along with a gelding operation to avert extra strain on his knees.

But the hitches didn't end there. The horse was registered as Out In The Street, only for connections to later be asked to change the name when someone discovered another son of Street Boss, running around to no great effect in country South Australia, called Outinthestreet.

Finally, the freshly-recuperated and newlynamed Elite Street made it to the track as a three-year-old - a year less a day before last Saturday's Winterbottom. He ran fourth in a three-year-old race at Ascot, pulled up lame the It's In The Blood - Trevor Marshallsea Column

following morning, and two more bone chips were discovered.

More surgery on both knees came, followed by another lengthy spell, but finally the skies cleared. That second-start fourth at Pinjarra preceded a winning run which would now be six straight but for a disqualification four runs back, at Belmont in July, owing to the presence of the therapeutic heptaminol.

Fingers crossed, the once-troubled Elite Street now looks well poised to go on to serve further justice to a pedigree which, as mentioned, is laced with speed.

Granddam Ateates is out of the Opera Prince mare Paris Miss, winner of the then Group 3 Light Fingers Stakes in 1989, which was given Group 2 status in 1991.

And Ateates was possibly not even Paris Miss' best sprinting progeny, since older sister Ruffles took the Group 1 VRC Newmarket in 1997 and Caulfield's Schillaci Stakes the year before.

Aside from the likes of Zeditave in the female line, going way back we find the strong presence of a British sprint god in Gold Bridge, appearing on both sides in the pedigree of Paris Miss's dam Diamonds, five generations earlier (therefore eight back from Elite Street).

Gold Bridge, born in 1929, won no fewer than 12 major sprints, including Royal Ascot's King's Stand Stakes twice and a Nunthorpe Stakes. He was equally as successful at stud, siring outstanding sprinters such as Golden Cloud (Nunthorpe) and Vilmorin (King's Stand) and becoming the sire of Rough Shod,

who became a blue hen broodmare in the US (Ridan, Moccasin, Lt Stevens, etc.).

While the Andersons inherited Elite Street, they are hopeful of more success from his dam Elite Ateates (who while owned in the west has never left the eastern states).

Her colt promising more ample speed – by Nicconi – sold for \$160,000 at this year's Magic Millions Yearling Sale in Perth. Named Elite Icon, the now two-year-old is reportedly showing considerable promise for Tony and Calvin McEvoy in South Australia.

Elite Ateates also has a yearling filly with the promise of a longer distance by Dundeel. There's now a colt on the ground from the first crop of Blue Diamond-winning sprinter Written By, and Elite Ateates was recently covered by multiple Group 1-winning US stallion Omaha Beach in his first season in Australia. "Elite Icon is a very nice looking colt and the McEvoys like him a lot, I hear," Anderson says.

"We're very happy to have the Dundeel filly. I think he's a great Classic producer, so we might keep that one and try to continue the line. There's the colt by Written By on the ground, and we're excited by the mating with Omaha Beach. He was a world-class racehorse, with a world-class pedigree, and we're lucky to have access to him in Australia."

Elite Street might not have been the punters' choice when prevailing at the \$31 in the Winterbottom, as local hero William Pike's odds-on mount Trekking battled into fourth. But after the sprinter's arduous passage to even get to the racetrack, it was a more than fitting reward for the Andersons after four decades in breeding.

oao Moreira stole the show once again with his fourth treble in a row at Happy Valley yesterday, and he capped his hattrick with a smart victory aboard Kinda Cool (Per Incanto) in the first section of the Class 4 Gloucester Handicap (1200m).

"It's not too difficult when you get an inside gate - he's been a nice horse, he has been a little bit unlucky with his gate and today it wasn't the case and I think it's paid off," Moreira said.

The Brazilian ace moves to an unrivalled 48 wins at the top of the jockeys' championship table, and has 12 victories from his last 25 rides, 20 wins clear of reigning champion Zac Purton, who missed Wednesday's fixture due to suspension.

"Frankie (Lor) had him very well for the race - it wasn't too complicated for me, I just had to make sure I didn't run into traffic and when I got him into the clear he just showed the ability that he has - he won with a little bit of authority," Moreira added.

The New Zealand-bred four-year-old grabbed his second win from seven starts in Hong Kong and, as a 60-rater at present, will move up to Class 3 next start.

But trainer Frankie Lor credited the good gate and gear change for the win: "He's drawn wide his last two starts here - I think at Happy Valley he needs a good draw and also, I gave him blinkers for the first time, he looks more concentrated."

Moreira kicked off his treble aboard Ready Conqueror (Better Than Ready), who staved off his rivals to win the Class 5 Lockhart Handicap (1000m), before driving the Caspar Fownes-trained Champ Patrol (Tavistock) to a comfortable win in the second section of the Class 4 Gloucester Handicap (1200m).

But Moreira almost made it a running fourtimer as We The South (Your Song) tried to go all-the-way, but was denied in the Class 3 Fleming Handicap (1000m) by Blake Shinn and Handsome Bo Bo (Helmet).

"I knew I was coming fast, I had a pretty good run from an awkward draw but the horse bounced well, he wanted to be in the fight the whole way," Shinn said.

The Helmet (Exceed And Excel) chesnut had his first run for Danny Shum on Wednesday, and his first since the end of May, to score a drought-breaking win that stretched all the way back to April 2018, and also returned first-up this season following a bone stress injury.

"Honestly the credit has to go to Danny (Shum), the horse is coming off an injury and he's only recently taken the horse over and he was on the top of his game tonight.

"I was just the lucky recipient to take the ride and it's great to be back riding for Danny to get my first win this season for him," Shinn said.

Shinn moves to six wins this term and secures his third from the last five race meetings.

Lui notches 700 Hong Kong wins

Francis Lui will have one of his biggest moments as a trainer when Golden Sixty (Medaglia d'Oro) runs for glory in the Hong Kong Mile (Gr 1, 1600m), but on Wednesday he notched a significant milestone of his own with his 700th Hong Kong win.

"I'm happy - I just try to win as many as I can," said Lui after Le Terroir's (Star Witness) win in the Class 3 Harbour Handicap (1200m) brought up the landmark success for the trainer.

Lui ended last term with a personal best 63 wins, which included a clean-sweep of the fouryear-old Classic series with Golden Sixty, and this term he has 18 wins and sits in fifth spot on the trainers' championship table.

Vincent Ho, who has been one of Lui's main allies in recent years and is Golden Sixty's regular rider, was in the plate for tonight's success.

"I was pretty confident tonight with the good draw, he improved again and he's done well for Francis (Lui)," Ho said.

Karis Teetan returned from a two-meeting suspension with a win, driving home the Dennis Yip-trained Murray's Partners (Towkay) to his fourth win from his last five starts in the Class 3 Thomson Handicap (1800m).

"He's going so well at the moment - from last season to now, even working him in the morning he just feels like such a different horse - it's a credit to Dennis (Yip) that he's had the horse turn a corner and start again," Teetan said.

Teetan also snapped a 36-ride winless streak that stretches back to November 11 at Happy Valley when he took home a treble. Wednesday's win was the Mauritian's 24th this term.

"He only just won it today but he's always been winning his races like that - I don't know how much more he has still to improve but he's doing everything right," Teetan said.

Peter Ho kept on rolling this term with his fifth win as Wonder Win (Pierro) overhauled Socket Elite (Savabeel) by a short-head in the Class 5 O'Brien Handicap (1800m).

Danny Shum and Alexis Badel combined in the opener, the Class 4 Jaffe Handicap (2200m) as Dynamic Eagle (Guillotine) outlasted the challenge of Above (Tavistock).

Hong Kong racing continues this Sunday (December 6) at Sha Tin.

Emotions run high as Coolmore land Palace Pier's dam at 2,200,000gns

he close of one chapter invariably begets the start of another further up the racing and breeding chain, and that was certainly the case at the Tattersalls December Mare Sale on Tuesday as Highclere Stud bid farewell to Beach Frolic (Nayef), dam of champion miler Palace Pier (Kingman), as the hammer fell in favour of Coolmore's MV Magnier at 2,200,000gns (approx. AUD\$4,183,500).

Having bred this year's two-time Group 1 winner, the nine-year-old daughter of Nayef (Gulch) looked a standout among the 1,108 entries in the four-day sale, and auctioneer Edmond Mahony duly went in search of a bid of two million when she took to the Park Paddocks ring.

Julian Dollar made a bold play when the Newsells Park Stud man threw in an opening offer of 1,000,000gns (approx. AUD\$1,900,000), but was soon joined by the likes of Alex Elliott, stationed at the top of the stairs with Kia Joorabchian, Rob Speers, who was taking instructions on the phone to the right of the rostrum, and an online bidder.

However, when Magnier, bidding outside by the parade ring, pushed the price to 2,200,000gns the other parties cried enough. A date with perennial champion sire Galileo (Sadler's Wells) now looks to be in the offing for Beach Frolic, who was offered in foal to Blue Point (Shamardal).

"She's a lovely mare and has already bred an exceptional racehorse," said Magnier. "The Highland Reel yearling that Jamie McCalmont bought this year was a very nice horse too and obviously Palace Pier is an exceptional horse.

"She's a special mare though and they don't come up very often. I'd say we're going to cover her with Galileo next year. Let's hope she's lucky for everyone involved. Lady Carolyn (Warren) and her team have done an amazing job with her the whole way through."



Beach Frolic

There was a poignancy to the result as Highclere had owned Beach Frolic in partnership with the late Duke of Roxburghe, whose Floors Stud had earlier held a part dispersal when seven of the Duke's mares fetched receipts totalling 1,308,000gns (approx. AUD\$2,500,000).

Highclere's John Warren bought Beach Frolic's granddam Miss D'Ouilly (Bikala), a Listed-winning half-sister to Prix Jacques le Marois (Gr 1, 1m) heroine Miss Satamixa (Linamix), for 50,000gns back in 2000, after which the Duke took a share.

The family has blossomed in the 20 years since, with Miss D'Ouilly and Night Shift's (Northern Dancer) daughter Night Frolic having bred Dante Stakes (Gr 2, 1m2.5f) scorer Bonfire (Manduro) and Windsor Forest Stakes (Gr 2, 1m) winner Joviality (Cape Cross), as well as Beach Frolic.

"I'm not normally emotional but she's just such an amazing mare and it's been such a long journey with her," said Highclere's Lady Carolyn Warren. "The family has given us so much pleasure and I hope for the Coolmore team that she does it for them too. I'm sure she will. All the team at Highclere do such an amazing job LAURA GREEN

day in, day out. She looked magnificent today so this result is for everybody."

John Warren added: "It's a bit of an end of an era as we've been involved so closely with Floors for 35 years. This whole week has been really poignant but I'm so pleased that the Duchess and her son George will be carrying on with a few nice mares.

"The relationship with the Duke of Roxburghe went beyond the horses, he was a special friend. Beach Frolic was a magnificent mare and was a collector's item in so many ways."

Moyglare's need for speed

It has been a little over 12 months since BBA Ireland signed for Sonaiyla (Dark Angel) at €110,000 at last year's Goffs November Sale when offered by the Aga Khan Studs. The daughter of Dark Angel (Acclamation) subsequently took her form to new heights for Paddy Twomey and Ennistown Stud and duly saw her value soar when Fiona Craig saw off Joseph O'Brien and Demi O'Byrne to add the filly to the Moyglare Stud broodmare band at a cost of 900,000gns (approx. AUD\$1,711,500).

Sonaiyla's four-year-old campaign has

seen the relation to Sinndar (Grand Lodge) land the Sweet Mimosa Stakes (Listed, 6f) and a valuable Curragh handicap, while she was beaten just a length into third by Glass Slippers (Dutch Art) in the Flying Five Stakes (Gr 1, 5f). Craig said her purchase would bring some much-needed sprinting blood to Moyglare's blue-chip broodmare band.

"It's basically a need for speed," said Craig, Moyglare Stud's bloodstock and breeding adviser. "I think that's why Joseph and Demi were bidding on her. She has something that we find hard to breed. She has that Group 1 placing and she's an outcross too."

Craig said a mating plan was still to be drawn up, but noted that Sonaiyla's pedigree meant that her new owners would not be short of options.

"With the exception of Dark Angel, she can go to any of the top 15 stallions by stakes winners," she said. "She can go to Frankel, Sea The Stars, Kingman, Galileo, Dubawi, she can go to all of those.

"She won the Sweet Mimosa, which is a good race, and hats off to Paddy - he's done an amazing job with her. I'm glad we got 450,000gns for Mia Maria earlier on. I didn't think we'd have to go that high for Sonaiyla, but we sold well and hopefully we've bought well too."

A second lot brought 900,000gns a short while later when Charlie Vigors from Hillwood Bloodstock secured the classy Kurious (Kuroshio), winner of the Coral Charge (Gr 3, 5f) for the Hot To Trot Racing syndicate.

The four-year-old, offered by Whitsbury Manor Stud, is by Kuroshio (Exceed And Excel) and out of Easy To Image (Cozzene), who also produced the Group 1-winning sprinters Tangerine Trees (Mind Games) and Alpha Delphini (Captain Gerrard).

"We're delighted and slightly amazed we got her," said Vigors. "She's a Group 3 and Listed winner out of a fantastic mare who is, when you consider the stallions she's been to, probably pound for pound one of the best producers of recent times - and that's no disrespect to the stallions she's been to at all.

"She's for the same clients who we sold yearlings for back in October. They're a group of British-based investors and they're reinvesting after a good round of yearling sales."

Blandford go back in Time

Another mare making a quick reappearance at public auction was Time Saver, a Frankel (Galileo) half-sister to Timepiece (Zamindar) and Passage Of Time (Dansili), who was signed for by Aquis Farm at 750,000gns some 12 months ago.

She was reoffered on Tuesday by Genesis Green Stud in foal to Kingman (Invincible Spirit) and duly went the way of Blandford Bloodstock's Richard Brown at 850,000gns (approx. AUD\$1,615,000).

"We went a long way on her last year," said Brown. "I can't remember quite how far but it was a hell of a long way as we thought she was the standout of last year's Juddmonte draft.

"She's come back in foal to a very exciting stallion and mares like this come on the market very rarely.

"It's an amazing family and a very active pedigree; there was another Grade 1 winner in America on there at the weekend [Viadera] and Time Test is a young stallion I have a lot of time for.

"She's been bought for a partnership of owner-breeders and she'll live with Luca and Sara Cumani at Fittocks Stud. We knew she'd be hard to buy so we put a partnership together to get her bought."

Date with Kameko on the cards for Dulkashe

A date with Tweenhills' 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1m)-winning recruit Kameko (Kitten's Joy) could be on the cards for Dulkashe (Pivotal) after David Redvers secured the daughter of

Pivotal (Polar Falcon) for 525,000gns (approx. AUD\$997,000).

The 11-year-old is best known as the dam of the much-missed Defoe (Dalakhani), winner of the 2019 Coronation Cup (Gr 1, 1m4f) for Roger Varian and Sheikh Mohammed Obaid. Dulkashe was offered by Miltown Park Stud in foal to Churchill (Galileo).

"We're buying a core group of mares and they'll be split between Kameko, Zoustar and one or two outside stallions," said Redvers. "She's going into that group and we'll have to sit down and decide which stallion suits her best - the idea was to get the mare first then worry about a covering later.

"A daughter of Pivotal who's thrown a Group 1 winner is a terribly rare commodity to come on the market. We'll have a long hard think about where she goes next year but Kameko would be a distinct possibility."

Floors Stud mares in demand

The part dispersal of the late Duke of Roxburghe's Floors Stud concluded on Tuesday with seven lots bringing receipts totalling 1,308,000gns. Anthony Stroud bought the most expensive of the septet when going to 425,000gns (approx. AUD\$807,000) for Deep Inside, a Redoute's Choice (Danehill) three-quarter sister to Chrysanthemum (Danehill Dancer) in foal to Lope De Vega (Shamardal).

Members of the late Duke's family were on hand to watch the mares sell, including Virginia Innes-Ker, the Duchess of Roxburghe, and two of their children, George and Isabella.

"It was sad as well as being exciting for the buyers," reflected George Innes-Ker. "I know Dad would be extremely proud of the team at home as they had the mares looking incredible. We're keeping fives mares though and we'll try to keep the Attraction name and Dad's legacy going. We'll have Attraction, Cushion, Motion, Titivation and Blinking.

"Blinking is 95 per cent blind but Dad was completely in love with her so keeping her is great. Attraction is carrying a Kingman filly this year and I know he'd be over the moon with that. Hopefully all goes well with her next year."

Attraction (Efisio) was the best horse bred by the late Duke, with the daughter of Efisio (Formidable I) having won five Group 1s, including the Anglo-Irish 1,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1m) and the following year's Matron Stakes (Gr 1, 1m).

On the future for the remaining Floors Stud mares, the Duchess of Roxburghe added: "Attraction and Blinking are going to Sara Cumani at Fittocks, she's looked after them and knows them incredibly well so that's where Guy would want them to go, and the other three are going to Watership Down."

Mia Maria ticks Carisbrooke's boxes

Yvonne Jacques made a noteworthy addition to her Carisbrooke Stud broodmare band when agent Cathy Grassick secured Moyglare Stud's Mia Maria (Dansili) with a bid of 450,000gns (approx. AUD\$855,000). The four-year-old daughter of Dansili (Danehill) is a winning sibling to three black type performers, including her dual Group 3-winning sister Carla Bianca, and was offered in foal to Lope De Vega by John Troy.

"There's lots we like about her," said Jacques. "There's her pedigree page, of course, and the fact she's in foal to Lope De Vega means a lot as we're very big fans of his. We're trying to focus on quality with our broodmares and she's one that we hope will be very lucky for us in the coming years."

Grassick added: "Yvonne has the only sister to Phoenix Of Spain so she really is a big fan of Lope De Vega. She's a big fan of Dansili as well as her Dansili filly Stylistique won a Listed race in France the other day. They're not making Dansili fillies any more so it's great to be able to get something that ticks so many boxes.

"Moyglare have only ever sold four fillies from this family; this filly and Candle Lit, who I bought for Clodagh and John McStay who bred Fresnel, so I've bought two of them now. It's a family you just can't go wrong with."

Opportunity knocks for Nerses

Tisa River (Equiano) was another mare who had appreciated in value since her last appearance at public auction, thanks in no small part to some punchy pedigree updates.

The six-year-old daughter of Equiano (Acclamation) is a half-sister to the Breeders' Cup-winning siblings Iridessa (Ruler Of The World) and Order Of Australia (Australia) and now joins the Blue Diamond Stud broodmare band after Tony Nerses went to 400,000gns (approx. AUD\$760,000).

She was offered in foal to Blue Point by Voute Sales on behalf of Khalid Almudhaf and Mohammed Alqatami, who bought Tisa River through Hugo Merry for 60,000gns two years ago.

The mare is out of Senta's Dream (Danehill), who has really clicked with sire sons of Galileo such as Ruler Of The World and Australia, and her daughter will now visit another son of the perennial champion sire in the Irish National Stud's Decorated Knight.

"When opportunity knocks, you have to grab it and that's exactly what we did as it's not very often a half-sister to two Breeders' Cup winners comes on the market," said Nerses. "She's got a lovely covering as well so we're very glad to have her. She'll be heading to our boy Decorated Knight."

Coleman in action early

The first major strike on Tuesday came from Matt Coleman, who bagged Aperitif, a daughter of Pivotal from Lordship Stud's famed Swiss Lake (Indian Ridge) family, with a bid of 300,000gns (approx. AUD\$570,000). The four-year-old, who was offered in foal to Ten Sovereigns (No Nay Never), is out of the Listedwinning Swiss Dream (Oasis Dream), making her a half-sister to Hackwood Stakes (Gr 3, 6f) scorer Yafta (Dark Angel), who has been recruited to Haras de Saint Arnoult for 2021. In turn, Swiss Dream is one of four black type performers out of Swiss Lake, with her siblings including Swiss Diva (Pivotal), Swiss Spirit (Invincible Spirit) and Swiss Franc (Mr Greeley).

"I bought her for Noel O'Callaghan of Mountarmstrong Stud," said Coleman from his position on the back stairs. "Noel likes to buy quality mares from good pedigrees and obviously Pivotal mares are hard to get hold of.

"She's from Lordship Stud's magnificent family, and it's not only a family of racehorses but commercial sales horses as well. Noel will be trying to breed for Book 1 and her progeny will no doubt be sold in future. She's carrying a colt so if she gets a nice Ten Sovereigns foal hopefully that'll get some of her purchase price back."

Coleman said no plans had been put in place with regards to a 2021 covering for Aperitif, but explained that O'Callaghan would be looking to repeat the sales ring success he had enjoyed with a purchase from the 2018 December sales.

He said: "We bought a mare off Juddmonte called Fine Time [for 420,000gns] two years ago, she's a sister to Timepiece, and her yearling made 475,000gns at Book 1. That was a similar buy to this mare in that she's from a big family. That was the last big mare we bought together, but we shop when we see the right mare rather than saying we're definitely going to come and buy one.

"There's Pivotal, Oasis Dream and Indian Ridge in Aperitif's pedigree and they're three of the best broodmare sires of all time so hopefully she's got the ingredients to be a really good broodmare."

Later in the session Swiss Air, a daughter of Oasis Dream (Green Desert) and Swiss Lake carrying to Dark Angel, sold to Anthony Stroud of Stroud Coleman Bloodstock for 390,000gns (approx. AUD\$741,000).
